Back when we started Power Sweep there was no internet and the mail system was reliable. Every Sunday night after the NFL games were complete and lines started popping up in Vegas for the next weeks action we wrote Power Sweep and sent it to the press on Monday morning. We had to scramble for the latest information on the games including injuries, etc. We also could not write about the Sunday or Monday games that had not been played yet. Now going to the press on Wednesday we have all the information on all the games, the latest injuries and all the lines have made their moves and are now stable. By moving to Wednesday you will receive sharper lines, the most up to date information and best of all 2024 should deliver a big season of Winners!!!

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# COLLEGE SELECTIONS

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## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Virginia Tech over VANDERBILT** - These two have met nine times but the last meeting was back in 1989. VTech is one of the most experienced teams in the country with 21 starters back under 3rd year HC Brent Pry. The Hokies started 1-3 last year but their season turned around when Kyron Drones took over at QB full time. Drones had a 17-3 ratio and ran for over 800 yards. Vandy's D allowed 36 ppg and 5.1 ypc last year. The 'Dores do have 15 starters back, adding New Mexico St QB Diego Pavia who led the upset win over Auburn last year. VTech is favored by nearly 2 td's and last year their seven wins were by 23.7 ppg. Vandy is only 4-15 ATS at home under Clark Lea and the Hokie faithful could outnumber Vandy's fan base here. Last year we used Virginia Tech for our 4★ top newsletter play in the opening week and the Hokies came through for us. The Hokies have shown they will get distance on inferior teams and with Vandy's lack of home edge you might as well play Enter Sandman when this one starts! Go Hokies!

**FORECAST: Virginia Tech by 28**

**3★ Tcu over STANFORD (Friday)** - TCU is 3-0 SU (1-2 ATS) all-time vs Stanford. They last met in the 2017 Alamo Bowl, where TCU won 39-37. TCU returns 16 starters including QB Hoover and their top 2 WR's, plus their defense has a ton of depth & talent. Stanford is in year 2 under HC Taylor. They return 18 starters led QB Daniels, their top 2 WR's and six of their top seven tacklers. Stanford is on a 1-14 SU/4-11 ATS slide at home vs FBS foes and won't really have any home field edge as the students aren't even back on campus yet. TCU is 2-0 SU/ATS in road non-conf games under Dykes and overall here Dykes is 4-2-1 ATS as road chalk. TCU has the edge on offense (#30 vs #69), defense (#24 vs #72) and ST's (#80 vs #130). Plus, all 5 of TCU's win LY were by 17+ points, so they can get distance on teams. While Stanford is improved from last season, this TCU team is quite talented themselves and we like the Horn Frogs to roll by over 2 td's.

**FORECAST: TCU by 17**

**3★ GEORGIA SOUTHERN (+) over Boise St** - First meeting. Boise returns All-American RB Ashton Jeanty and all 11 starters on defense and are led by Spencer Danielson, who was the interim LY and was given the full-time job. GS is in year three under HC Helton and have a new QB in JC French, but with 8 starters back on defense that unit will be solid. The last two seasons Boise is 0-4 SU/0-3-1 ATS in road non-conf games and Statesboro is a tough place to play, especially at this time of year with the heat & humidity that Boise is not used to. GS has a pair of home upsets under HC against JMU and App St in 2022. This line is approaching 2 td's and we feel like that is too many points for Boise St against a quality GSthn team that we think will keep this game close and they will be playing in front of a spirited home crowd.

**FORECAST: Boise St by 6**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ SYRACUSE over Ohio** - Syracuse is 3-0 SU vs Ohio with their last meeting in '21 when the Bobcats hosted and lost 29-9 (+1). There is a lot of excitement in Syracuse with a new coaching staff under Fran Brown and they brought in Ohio St transfer QB Kyle McCord (3170, 66%, 24-6). Syracuse returns 18 starters including 1,000 yd rusher LeQuint Allen, All-ACC LB Marlowe Wax and WR/TE Oronde Gadsden returns from injury. HC Brown tapped his SEC experience and brought in some other key transfers like DE Fadil Diggs (A&M), Zeed Haynes (UGA) and Duce Chestnut (LSU) who was a two year starter here in '21-'22. Ohio is the least experienced team in the FBS with just six starters back. Their starting QB transferred to Indiana and they lost their top two RB's, top seven receivers and their top four tacklers. Syracuse is 20-0 SU vs the MAC since 1999 and are 18-2 ATS in those games! We think Fran Brown will get things started in a big way and easily cover the 17' point spread.

**FORECAST: SYRACUSE by 28**

**2★ Wyoming (+) over ARIZONA ST** - These teams have met 15 times prior but the last meeting was way back in 1977. This is the opener for both schools and Ariz St is off a 3-9 season in year 1 under HC Dillingham but only bring back 10 starters overall including just 4 on defense. Wyoming lost HC Bohl in the offseason, but promoted from within & now DC Jay Sawvel is the HC and they bring back 13 starters. WY's best offensive weapon RB Waylee had minor knee surgery a few weeks ago and is ? here (check staus) but they will rely on strong-armed QB Svoboda to make some throws & they will be more aggressive on offense. Ariz St is just 5-10 ATS since 2019 as home chalk and have failed to cover their last 5 games in home non-conf games vs FBS foes. Wyoming is a tough team and HC Sawvel will have them believing they can pull the outright upset.

**FORECAST: Wyoming by 3**

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY AUGUST 29th

**North Carolina by 6 over MINNESOTA** - North Carolina's first trip to Minnesota. The Gophers lost the only meeting 31-13 (+7) last year in Chapel Hill. North Carolina took a 21-10 (320-112 yd edge) lead going into half and behind QB Drake Maye's 414 yards did not look back. This year both team's have new QB's, Minnesota is lead by Max Brosmer who was #1 in the FCS in pass YPG last year at New Hampshire and North Carolina has Max Johnson who started 8 games (12-5 ratio) the last two years at Texas A&M. The Tar Heels are 10-3 SU vs non-conference opponents since '20 but all three losses were to Notre Dame. This is the eighth straight year that Minnesota opens up at home but are 2-5-1 ATS. We will give the Tar Heels the edge behind All-American running back Omarion Hampton but look for this to be a close matchup!

**JACKSONVILLE ST by 7 over Coastal Carolina** - Meet for the 2nd year in a row and third overall. Last year CC (-13') led 10-9 at the half but CC scored 20 straights pts 2H before JSU scored td mid 4Q and CC held on for the win & cover as JSU was SOD inside the 20, however the yards were almost even (399-393 CC). Last season CC was 2-1 ATS as an AD including an outright upset at App St. CC returns 12 starters (#103 experience) but needs to find a new QB and replace their top 2 WR's. Jax St has just 9 starters back (#92 experience) but QB Smothers has start exp and they ran for 237 ypg last season and CC allowed 209 rush ypg in non-conf gms LY. Plus Jax St has the coaching edge with Rich Rod over Tim Beck. Jax St is 5-1 SU/ATS at home as an FBS team and are laying under a fg here, so we'll give our lean to the Gamecocks here.

### FRIDAY AUGUST 30th

**OKLAHOMA by 49 over Temple** - Temple has lost 7 straight vs ranked teams, and 1-6 ATS in that span. OU is 18-0 SU/12-6 ATS in home openers including a dominant 73-0 performance against Ark St last year. OU has the experience edge with 15 starters back (#38 in exp) while Temple only has 10 back (#129 exp). The Sooners return their top RB, five of their top six receivers and top six tacklers. They did lose all 5 starting OL but added five transfers and have 114 career starts on the OLine. QB Jackson Arnold takes over for departed Dillon Gabriel. Arnold started the bowl game and faces a Temple Pass D that was dead last in the FBS in pass D efficiency last year. Oklahoma can name the score here and the Sooners are 9-1 ATS when favored by 40 points or more since 2007.

**WISCONSIN by 21 over Western Michigan** - First meeting since the 2017 Cotton Bowl, Wisoconsin (-7) winning 24-16. Wisconsin has won 16 consecutive season openers vs non-conference but are just 7-5 ATS vs non-conf since '20. In the last two years Western Michigan is 2-6 SU/4-4 ATS vs non-conf but in '21 did upset Pittsburgh (+14') 44-41. Wisconsin is in the second year of the Luke Fickell era and bring in QB Tyler Van Dyke who started 28 games at Miami, Fl. Western Michigan in the first year under HC Lance Taylor went 4-8 SU/7-5 ATS but this year they have SR QB Hayden Wolf and an experienced defense. We expect Wisconsin to win this game but will cut our lean off at 3 td's.

**MICHIGAN ST by 8 over Fau** - 4th meeting. MSU has outscored the Owls a combined 91-7. Last meeting was in '11, MSU (-32) shutout the Owls 44-0. FAU is 1-11 SU vs the current Big 10 but did keep it close with Illinois last year (+16) losing 23-17. MSU is 24-1 SU but are 12-13 ATS in home openers, lone loss was in '20. A new era begins in East Lansing as new HC Jonathan Smith and a roster overhaul of transfers play their first game as Spartans. Smith at Oregon St as an home favorite was 15-3! FAU is headlined by Marshall transfer Cam Fancher (17 car starts, 21-17 ratio) and a D that is returning 8 starters. FAU HC Tom Herman is 19-8 ATS vs non-conference and 8-3 ATS as an AD in his career. With the new MSU roster we will side with Herman and the Owls to keep it close.

### SATURDAY AUGUST 31st

**INDIANA by 28 over Fiu** - Indiana has won the previous three meetings (2-1 ATS). The Hoosiers bring in James Madison HC Curt Cignetti who is 119-35 in his career, along with a number of JMU transfers also former MAC POY QB Kurtis Rourke. FIU under HC Mike Macintyre are just 4-8 SU on the road but were 3-1 SU in non-conference games with their lone loss being a cover (+29) vs Arkansas 44-20 last season. The Panthers are led by Keyone Jenkins who threw for 2,414 yards as a True. Indiana has won 11 straight non-conference home openers. We think Cignetti will want to get the fans fired up with a dominant win and they only have lowly Western Illinois (24 gm losing streak) on deck.

**PITTSBURGH by 24 over Kent St** - These schools are just 114 miles apart. Pitt's offense is going to look less robotic under new OC Kade Bell who led Western Carolina to 38 ppg and 504 ypg last year. Kenni Burns is in his 2nd year as HC at Kent State. The Golden Flashes were just 1-11 last year. They do have 13 starters back. Devin Kargman, who started 1 game last year (297, 53%, 2-0) was named the starting QB. Pitt's Dline and LB's are inexperienced and they lost DLine coach Charlie Partridge. Narduzzi has said both Nate Yarnell (3 car st) and Alabama transfer Eli Holstein will play and are still competing for the starting job. Pitt does have a revenge game at Cincy on deck. The line is Pitt -24 and there are too many question marks in this game for us to have a strong lean.

**MARYLAND by 30 over UConn** - 4th meeting as these teams first met in 1942 (Maryland 34-0) and they most recently split a home & home series in '12-'13. Maryland is on a 18 game winning streak in home openers (10-5 ATS). The Terrapins lose their all-time leading passer in Tualia Tagovaliloa (11,256) but replace him with NC State transfer MJ Morris (4 sts, 7-5 ratio LY). Along with Morris they bring back #1 RB and #2 WR along with a defense that allowed 23.3 PPG while having 8 starters back this year. UConn returns QB Fagnano and the dynamic pair of RB's Edwards and Rosa. The Huskies were 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS versus P4 opponents last season. We like the Terrapins to win big here.

**UTSA by 26 over Kennesaw St** - Kennesaw St joins the FBS this year. UTSA has 14 starters back and are among the favorites in the AAC. They lose QB Frank Harris but Owen McCown looked good in the bowl game and completed 74% last year. Kennesaw St went 3-6 last year, but all three wins were against D2/NAIA schools and they lost their last eight vs FBS/FCS schools. UTSA is the best team that Kennesaw saw and they lost since '22 when the Owls were crushed at Cincinnati 63-10 (+29). Traylor is only 1-4 as a 20+ favorite and they do have a big game against Texas St on deck. Our lean is with the Roadrunners but not strong enough to make a play.

**Georgia by 8 over Clemson** - These two met in the opener in '21 when neither team scored an offensive td and UGA's Pick-6 led to a 10-3 win. This game is being played in Georgia's home away from home, Mercedes Benz Stadium. The Dawgs have played here at least once each year since '17, going 5-5 SU/ATS. The Dawgs have a slight experience edge with 14 starters back including QB Carson Beck while Clemson has 14 starters back as well including QB Cade Klubnik. The Tigers were much better than their 9-4 record suggested last year. They held a yardage edge in 3 of their 4 losses and were +34 FD's in those four games. UGA is the most talented team in the country. Clemson isn't far behind and we expect better from Klubnik in his 2nd year as a starter. This is actually just the third time ever, and first since 2014 that Dabo is a double-digit underdog. He is 2-0 ATS in that role and 12-2 ATS as a dog of 5+ points. We don't think the Tigers will pull the upset but they will make it competitive.

**Eastern Michigan by 3 over UMass** - UMass is 2-3 SU in this series but have covered all five meetings. EMich has won the last three meetings including last year when UMass led 17-13 4Q before allowing the game-winning td with 1:20 left. UMass has the experience edge (#98 vs #124). Don Brown is in his 3rd year as HC at UMass. The Minutemen went from 1-11 in Brown's first year to 3-9 last year and has 11 starters back including QB Taisun Phommachanh but they did lose an 1100 yard rusher and five of their top eight tacklers. EMich also has 11 starters back and added Buffalo transfer QB Cole Snyder who threw 31 td passes in two years and topped 3K passing in '22. UMass is a small favorite and we've documented Chris Creighton's amazing underdog record (28-9 as an away dog since '16). We will take the Eagles to win outright but would like it more if they were getting at least 3 points.

**GEORGIA TECH by 27 over Georgia St** - Despite these schools being in the same city, this is the first meeting. GT is off an upset win against Florida St in Dublin last week. GT outgained FSU 336-291 and held them to 98 rush yards (3.2) including just 40 yards after FSU's first drive. GA State enters '24 in a tough situation as their lost their HC during spring practice. New HC McGee's team returns just 10 starters (#113 experience) as they lose their QB, top 2 RB's, top WR and 4 starting OL. This is a sandwich game for GT as they are off an emotional win and have a road ACC game vs Syracuse on deck. However, GT is 3-1 ATS off of a double-digit upset under HC Key. GT has big edges on offense (#15 vs #128) and ST's (#54 vs #120). GT will be playing with confidence and this GA State team could take some time to get going with so many new starters, so give us the Yellow Jackets!

**SOUTH CAROLINA by 20 over Old Dominion** - First meeting. ODU has one faced one other SEC foe, losing to Vandy 42-28 back in '14. South Carolina is 7-2 ATS as double-digit chalk since '20 and are laying 3 td's here. The Gamecocks have 15 starters back but lost #4 DC QB Spencer Rattler and replace him with 6'3" 240 lb rF LaNorris Sellers. They made a big addition at RB with Rocket Sanders who rushed for over 1,400 yards in '22 at Arkansas. They also have 8 starters back on defense. ODU has just 10 starters back including QB Grant Wilson who had a 17-8 ratio last year. They also get back LB Jason Henderson who had 135 tackles last year and was a 2nd Team AA. ODU lost seven games last year but only one by more than 3 td's and they only lost to Virginia Tech by 19 and Wake Forest by just a fg. The Gamecocks have their SEC opener on deck at Kentucky and ODU is 6-2 ATS since '18. Our line is just under 3 td's.

**James Madison by 16 over CHARLOTTE** - 3rd meeting, but first with both teams at the FBS level. Charlotte is in year two under HC Poggi and return 12 starters from a team that went 3-9 LY, but they added several transfer including QB Max Brown from Florida. JMU lost their HC and several of their top players to Indiana, so they bring in new HC Chesney from Holy Cross and return just 6 starters. JMU did add talent via the portal including QB Dylan Morris (Washington) RB Adayi (N.Texas) and 2x Patriot League DPOY LB Jacob Hobbs who played under HC Chesney. Charlotte is just 3-9 ATS since 2021 as a home dog, including 1-4 ATS under Poggi last season. These schools are less than 300 miles apart and JMU could have a decent amount of fans here. Poggi also announced that the 49ers could be without 9 starters for this game which has made the line jump. We already thought JMU had the talent edge and with the injuries we will call for the Dukes to win by more than 2 td's.

**Penn St by 13 over WEST VIRGINIA** - First time WVU hosts Penn St since 1992! Last season was the first meeting in 31 years and after the game was tied 7-7 PSU scored 24 straight points and scored a td with 6 seconds left 4Q to get the cover (won 38-15, -20') and PSU was +170 yards. PSU returns 13 starters including QB Allar and their dynamic 1-2 punch at RB in Singleton and Allen. They also have a dominant defense with 7 starters back. WVU will have the fans on their side & they return QB Greene and a stellar OL. Since 2021 Penn St is 8-1 SU/ATS as a road favorite including covering the last seven. Last season the line was almost 3 td's and now is slightly over a td. While WVU has gone 5-3 SU/ATS as a home dog since '20 we don't think WVU has closed the gap that much on PSU and think the Nittany Lions defense travels and limits the WVU offense. We'll take PSU by almost 2 td's.

**KENTUCKY by 34 over Southern Miss** - Southern Miss upset Kentucky in '16 44-35 (+6) but since then the Golden Eagles are 0-7 SU/2-5 ATS against the SEC. The 'Cats got their revenge the following year in the opener at Hattiesburg but failed to cover -9' (24-17). KY has 18 starters back and turn to UGA transfer Brock Vandagriff at QB. Their Dline is a strength with all four starters back and allowed just 113 rush ypg (3.3) and had 35 sacks last year. Smiss has just 10 starters back. They added Florida St transfer QB Tate Rodemaker who has two career starts. The 'Cats have covered their last three home openers, all over G5 programs, winning by 30 ppg. They have also won 20 straight non-conference regular season games (14-6 ATS) and are 13-0 SU/9-4 ATS in the month of September the last 3 years. KY has a huge edge on defense here (#13 vs #111). We don't see Southern Miss moving the ball much on Kentucky and the 'Cats pressure could lead to turnovers which would lead to an extra td or two.

**OHIO ST by 51 over Akron** - Akron is 1-8 SU including 2-2 ATS since '01 and are the only Ohio FBS team to beat the Buckeyes back in 1894. Teams last met in '21 when Ohio St (-48') put up 622 of total offense in route to a 59-7 victory. The Buckeyes have outscored MAC teams 247-43 in their last four matchups. Akron will be improved this year but with non-conference games vs Rutgers and South Carolina on deck look for the Zips to not get too beat up. Ohio St went into the portal for key positions, K State QB Will Howard, Bama Saf Downs and Ole Miss RB Judkins. Under Moorhead the Zips are 1-3 ATS vs P4 foes, losses by 52, 57, 32 and 2 (Indiana 4OT LY). As a favorite of 20 or more OSU is 11-7 ATS last 3 years. OSU has a deep QB room and with Western Michigan on deck expect the Buckeyes to test out their offense under new OC Chip Kelly and win big.

**ARIZONA by 34 over New Mexico** - This will be the 67th meeting, and last met in 2015 in the New Mexico Bowl. NMex does have a game under their belt after facing Montana St last week. The Lobos were outgained 567-324 vs Montana St last week despite losing 35-31 (2 fumble return td's). New QB Dampier looked good in the opener (18-26, 172, 2 total td). Arizona has a new HC in Brent Brennan (26-19 L4Y San Jose St) and while many players left via the portal, they still have star WR McMillan and QB Fifta plus 5 of the top 6 tacklers on defense. Since '21 NMex is 0-3 SU/ATS as a dog of 30+ points with the average loss coming by 38 points. Arizona only has an FCS team on deck, so this is not a lookahead spot and despite the close score last week NMex was outplayed last week and now face a talented P4 team.

**FLORIDA by 1 over Miami, FI** - This is Miami's first trip to The Swamp since 2008 when they lost 26-3 (+22') but Florida has actually won 2 of the last 3 meetings. Florida HC Billy Napier starts the season on the hot seat and they face the toughest schedule in the

country, but the early part of the schedule is manageable and if they win this game, they would have a great shot to start the season 6-1. Florida has 14 starters back including QB Graham Mertz who was #1 in the SEC in completion percentage last year (73%) and a 20-3 ratio. Miami was a big player in the Portal, adding Washington St's QB Cam Ward (67%, 25-7), Oregon St's Damien Martinez (1185, 6.1) and four other starters from P4 programs. In '22 Florida was a home underdog in the opener against Utah and pulled the upset 29-26 (+2'). Last year they upset Tennessee in The Swamp as well. We think Miami has the edge on all 3 phases but we think the home field is the difference and will call for Florida to win on a late fg by Trey Smack.

**TEXAS by 24 over Colorado St** - Texas comes in with lots of excitement after making the playoffs last year and joining the SEC. The last time these two met Earl Campbell ran for 103 yards and Texas won 46-0 in 1975. The Longhorns have 15 starters back including QB Quinn Ewers. CSU has a potent passing attack led by Braden Fowler-Nicolosi who threw for 3,460 last year and WR Tory Horton who had over 1100 yards receiving. HC Jay Norvell says P4 programs tried to poach them off the Rams roster but they stuck around. Texas' pass D had some struggles last year, allowing over 300 pass ypg in five of their last eight games including the Playoff Semifinal when Michael Penix lit them up for 430 yards. Last year Texas opened with Rice and were -35'. The Longhorns only won 37-10. This year they have a trip to Ann Arbor on deck and we expect a similar result, with CSU staying within the 32 point line.

**NEBRASKA by 35 over Utep** - First meeting. UTEP is 0-3 all-time vs the B10 including a 38-7 (E) loss last year at Northwestern. The Miners have never beaten a P4 team as they are 0-24 SU/6-18 ATS, 1-10 ATS in the last 11. Nebraska is 8-1 SU vs CUSA teams including last year when they played Louisiana Tech (-20') winning 28-14. UTEP has a new HC in Scotty Walden and his roster from Austin Peay came with him. The Huskers have Colorado on deck but with highly talented true Freshman Quarterback Dylan Raiola making his first career start for the Huskers we look for Nebraska to win their 6th straight home opener by 5 Td's!

**NORTHWESTERN by 7 Miami, Oh** - Northwestern will be playing their first three home games at an alternate campus location as Ryan field will be under construction. Miami have won 7 of the 10 in this series including an upset in '22 (+7') when the Redhawks kicked at GW FG with :51 winning 17-14. Miami HC Chuck Martin is 10-31 SU vs non-conference but are one of the favorites to win the MAC once again. They return veteran QB Brett Gabbert and their defense allowed just 16 PPG last season. Northwestern HC David Braun took over a team last year that had little expectations but ended up winning 7 games and going on to upsetting Utah (+6') in the bowl game 14-7. Both teams have experience on defense but we are going with the Wildcats to pull through in Evanston.

**Unlv by 7 over HOUSTON** - 4th meeting. UNLV is 0-3 SU all-time vs Houston and they last met in 2014 (UH 47-14 win). Houston is in year 1 under HC Willie Fritz, who comes over from Tulane and they have just 10 starters back. UNLV is in year 2 under HC Odom and they bring back their star WR White and bring in 2 FCS QB's who both are dual-threat playmakers. Fritz went 4-8 in year 1 at Tulane and it could take it some time to get this UH program going and UNLV is off a strong season and have a tough offense to defend with playmakers all across the unit. This game is right around a pick'em and we'll back the Rebels here, who have covered 12 straight non-conference games & HC Fritz was just 2-6 ATS last season in home games.

**North Texas by 1 over SOUTH ALABAMA** - Only the 2nd ever meeting. SALa comes into '24 with a new HC and they return just 7 starters overall (#128 experience) and they lose their QB, 1,000-yd RB and 1,300-yd WR plus 3 OL starters. N.Tex brings back 11 starters in year 2 under HC Morris and they add QB Chandler Morris who started 6 games LY at TCU. N.Tex was 3-1 ATS LY as an away dog and pulled one outright road upset LY and SALa could take some time to get their offense going and they face a N.Tex defense that should show improvement this fall. N.Tex is getting over a fg here and we like them to win the game outright.

**TROY by 17 over Nevada** - First meeting. This is the furthest trip east for a non-conf regular season game for Nevada since 2015 at Buffalo. Nevada has a game under their belt after they played SMU real close at home. Nevada led 17-10 HT (181-112) and led 24-13 into the 4Q but gave up 16 points (2 td's and 1 safety) and lost 29-24. Troy is year 1 under HC Parker and they lose a lot of talent from their B2B Sun Belt title teams as just 4 starters are back. Troy's program has an expectation to compete and they will have a great home crowd & the temps will be in the 90s with high humidity. The 'Pack looked to be improved and HC Choate will have them ready but we think Troy will still have a competitive team and will have their way with Nevada in this one.

**RICE by 4 over Sam Houston** - Rice is 16-1 all-time in this series but these two haven't met since 1993. Rice has 15 starters back. They added Temple transfer EJ Warner (son of Kurt) who threw for 3,076 (58%, 23-12) last year. Their top RB and top 6 tacklers also return. SH has 12 starters back and they added QB Hunter Watson who led his team to a JUCO National Title last year. The Bearcats covered as double-digit dogs against BYU, Air Force, Liberty and WKU last year. Keeler is 10-4 as an away dog. Rice has been a double-digit favorite vs an FBS team twice under Bloomgren and lost both outright, losing to UConn 38-31 (-10) last year and to Charlotte 56-23 (-15') in '22. We see plenty of reasons to think Sam Houston will keep this within the 10 point line.

SALa comes into '24 with a new HC and they return just 7 starters overall (#128 experience) and they lose their QB, 1,000-yd RB and 1,300-yd WR plus 3 OL starters. NTex brings back 11 starters in year 2 under HC Morris and they add QB Chandler Morris who started 6 games LY at TCU. NTex was 3-1 ATS last year as an away dog and pulled one outright road upset against Louisiana Tech. The Mean Green defense did give up 255 rush ypg but the emphasis has been to stop the run in the offseason. South Alabama has a young offense with just 4 starters back and only 3 starters back on D. With North Texas getting over a fg here we will take the Mean Green to cover and we think they will even pull the outright upset!!!

**FORECAST: North Texas by 3**

**Ucla by 10 HAWAII** - First time Hawaii is hosting UCLA in a regular season game. Last met in '21 at UCLA where the Bruins (-17) won 44-10 (+123 yds, +2 TO's). UCLA enters '24 with new HC Deshaun Foster and 12 starters are back including QB Garbers. Hawaii did play last week at home vs Delaware St and led just 14-7 HT (131-101) and won 35-14 but only outgained DST 331-260. Hawaii is in year 3 under HC Chang and they have an experienced team back (#6) led by QB Schager but he only hit 50% last week. This is tough trip for a new HC for his first game and LY UH was a 14+ pt dog at home once and pulled the outright upset. We think UCLA ultimately wins, but this is a scrappy Hawaii team that we see playing better and giving the Bruins a game.

**ALABAMA by 41 over Wku** - WKU has four wins over SEC foes including over Arkansas in '19 but the 'Toppers are biting off more than they can chew here. Bama has won 43 straight vs non-Power 4 foes. Bama has 13 starters back including QB Jalen Milroe. The Tide opened last year with a 56-7 (-39) win over Middle Tennessee and also beat Utah St 55-0 (-41) in the '22 opener. DeBoer is 11-1-1 ATS in non-conference games so we expect a similar result. WKU was crushed last year at Ohio St 63-10 (+30) and HC Helton is 0-6 ATS as a double-digit dog. WKU does have 14 starters back including former Auburn QB TJ Finley who threw for 3,439 yards last year at Texas St. The biggest concern for WKU is a defense that allowed over 28 ppg and 420 ypg last year and has just five starters back. Bama has won their last six vs G5 foes by 51.2 ppg and won't have to look ahead to USF and DeBoer will want to impress the Bama faithful with a dominant win.

**MICHIGAN by 27 over Fresno St** - First meeting. It is a meeting of new coaches as Sheronne Moore takes over for Michigan and Tim Skipper takes over for Fresno St after Jeff Tedford stepped down this summer. Fresno is 8-4 ATS in road non-conf games since 2017, but most of those were under Tedford. Michigan is just 2-6 ATS since 2019 in home non-conf games as a favorite of 20+ points. The 'Under' also hit in all 3 of Michigan's home non-conf games as 20+ point chalk last season (avg 37 ppg). Michigan does have a tough home non-conf game on deck vs Texas, but they still have an incredibly strong defense that will limit the Fresno offense and "The Big House" is always a tough place to play. The line is right around 3 td's here and we like Michigan to get a big win in their opener and gain confidence heading into their matchup vs Texas.

**TEXAS A&M by 3 over Notre Dame** - These two last met in '01 when A&M won 24-3 (-3). A&M brings in HC Mike Elko who was DC at Notre Dame in '17. Aggies have won their last 6 season openers and are 11-0 SU/7-4 ATS in home openers. The Aggies have 18 starters back including QB Connor Weigman who has a 16-2 ratio in the last two years but was OFY after 4 games last year. Notre Dame has 15 starters back and brought in Elko's QB from Duke in Riley Leonard. If the Irish win this game they will likely be favored in their first 11 games. Elko did a phenomenal job at Duke, winning 16 games in two years. Elko's Duke squad gave Notre Dame everything they could handle last year and he has a far more talented team now than he did at Duke. Elko was 11-2 at home with not much atmosphere. Now he has a crazy home crowd in College Station and we think that's the difference in a close game.
