4★ INDIANA over Maryland - Indiana is one of the hottest teams in the country, covering all 4 games and they are +315 ypg. Since becoming conference foes in '14 the teams have split the series 5-5 but Maryland has won 3 straight. Last year Indiana (+14) went down 27-3 at half and couldn't comeback in a 44-17 loss. MD scored 44 points in just 21:56 of possession time. The over is 8-2 in this series. Hoosiers enter this matchup being 4-0 for the first time s/20. IU's offense has been impressive averaging 514 ypg and 51 ppg. Indiana has held all four foes to their season low yards, giving up just 199 ypg! MD is coming off a 38-20 win over Villanova and in their road opener (-1) at Virginia were +4 TOs to win 27-13. Curt Cignetti is now 44-22 ATS as a head coach including 4-0 so who better to back as our Top Newsletter Play!

FORECAST: INDIANA by 20

3★ UNLV over Fresno St - UNLV has lost the last 6 meetings vs Fresno, but the last three have all been by 8 pts or less & the Rebels covered those three games as an underdog. UNLV is off to a 3-0 start for the first time in 40 years and have two P4 wins under their belt, beating Houston and Kansas. The Rebels are avg 293 rush ypg (5.6). Their defense is allowing just 301 ypg and their pass D is giving up just 54% (#32 ranked pass D). Fresno is sitting at 3-1 but their wins are vs an FCS team, NMex St and New Mexico. In that game vs NMex they were outgained 485-345, but benefited from being +3 TO's. Fresno QB Keane only has a 6-4 ratio and Fresno is avg'g just 135 rush ypg (3.5). The Rebels were favored in this game until news broke that QB Matthew Sluka left the team due to "unfulfilled commitments" but he was only completing 43% and backup Hajj Malik-Williams is also a dangerous runner. HC Odom is 13-4 ATS here we think the team will rally together after their QB essentially quit on them. We liked the Rebels here by double-digits and the QB change actually favors us with the line movement.

FORECAST: UNLV by 11

3★ OLE MISS over Kentucky - These two last met in '22 and Ole Miss only won 22-19 (-6). Rebels have dominated all four opponents. They average 607 ypg and have held all 4 foes to their season low yards, giving up just 239 ypg and 35 ypg rush (1.1)! We cashed a 3H LPS on Kentucky last week in their 41-6 (-19) win over Ohio. The 'Cats allow 217 ypg and have also held all 4 foes to their season low in yards but their offense only avg 318 ypg. While the 'Cats did nearly upset Georgia a few weeks ago, the Ole Miss offense is a different animal and this game is on the road. Stoops is now 2-29 SU/10-19-2 ATS vs teams that finish with a winning SEC record. The Rebels are certainly on their way and their huge edge on offense should be enough to clear 3 td's easily!

FORECAST: OLE MISS by 28

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Cincinnati over TEXAS TECH - Only the 2nd ever meeting. Cincy cashed another 4★ play on these pages last week and also was a 4★ late phone winner for us, as they led Houston 24-0 HT and won 34-0. TT is off a 30-22 win vs Ariz St, where they won despite getting outgained. Cincy is 3-1 (could be 4-0) as QB Sorsby is hitting 65% (8-0 ratio) and RB Kiner has a pair of 100+ yd gms (404, 6.3). TT has a strong offense of their own (488 ypg) led by QB Morton (63%, 12-2 ratio) and RB Brooks (379, 5.3) but Cincy is doing a solid job of stopping the run (139, 4.5) and they are +4 TO's vs FBS foes. The biggest edge in this game for Cincy is their defense (#46 vs #84) as TT has allowed 444 ypg. The Bearcats have played well and we will continue to ride them here!

FORECAST: Cincinnati by 7

2★ Iowa St over HOUSTON - First meeting. ISU is off to a 3-0 start and were impressive last week in a 52-7 win vs Ark St, where they led 31-0 HT (+186 yds) and were +308 yds for the game. UH dropped to 1-3 on the season with a 34-0 loss at Cincy where they only put up 233 yds and were held under 14 pts for the 3rd time this ssn. ISU also has a road win at Iowa in their back pocket, so won't be intimidated going on the road here. QB Becht is hitting 68% (6-2 ratio) and broke out for 237 rush yds (4.9) last week. ISU's defense is a strong point of this team, allowing just 260 ypg & 10 ppg and their pass defense ranks #5 giving up just 113 ypg and only 48% completions! ISU has the huge offensive edge in this game (#42 vs #108). ISU has typically struggled as a big favorite under HC Campbell, but showed no sign of that last week while UH struggled to move the ball vs Cincy last week and here face an even better defense. We think the Cyclones go to Houston and take care of business by almost 3 td's!

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 26TH

Army vs TEMPLE - First meeting as conference foes. Temple leads the series 3-2 (3-1 ATS) but last time met ('16) Army (+15) pulled off the upset thanks to +3 TO, winning 28-13. The Owls are 17-7-1 ATS vs Military Academy teams since 2000 including and already faced Navy in week 2 and Coastal Carolina two weeks ago. The Owls are coming off back-to-back Home Dog covers, last week (+6) vs Utah St scored a TD on 4 straight possessions in the 2H to win 45-29. In their first AAC game LW Army (-7) went up 28-0 at H and didn't look back, winning 37-14 vs Rice. Army HC Jeff Monken is 5-8 ATS as an Away Favorite and is just 3-6 SU on the road last 3 years. Temple does a good job defending the Triple Option and is a home dog but Army is 3-0 for just the third time since '16. All Power Sweep Subscribers will get our Thursday Night College Marquee for free as part of our 5★ weekend!

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 27TH

MIAMI,FL by 20 over Virginia Tech - Visitor has won 4 of the last five meetings but Canes are laying 17 here. UM is 7-2 SU/6-3 ATS vs VT since '14 and they last met in '22 when UM was -8 on the road and won 20-14 but did have a 458-257 yard edge. VT trailed Rutgers at home 23-7 last week but scored two 4Q td's and two 2-pt conversions to tie then allowed a fg and lost 26-23. Last year Kyrn Drones rushed for 818 yards but this year only has 94 (2.2). UM has won & covered all four games. The 'Canes are +372 ypg and their offense averages 605 ypg! Cam Ward is #2 in the country with 1,439 passing (72%, 14-2). Miami only led USF 22-15 last week but outgained the Bulls 356-143 in the 2H and won 50-15 (-17). VT just allowed Rutgers to put up a season high 422 yards and Miami has put up the most yards all four of their foes have allowed. VT hasn't been impressive and we don't want to go against Miami so our lean is with the home chalk.

RUTGERS by 10 over Washington - First meeting since their home-&-home series in '16 and '17. Washington took both games in the series outscoring the Knights 78-27. Rutgers won their first home conference opener since 2012 (4-7 ATS) last year vs Northwestern (24-7, -6). Washington is coming of their first Big 10 win. UW (-12) outgained Northwestern 391-112 and had the 22-12 first down edge in a 24-5 win. Last week The Knights (+3) went on the road at Virginia Tech, held the 23-7 lead going into the 4Q but allowed 2 TDs then were able to kick a GW FG with 1:56 left. Rutgers as a fav of single digits is 7-2 ATS the last 3 ssn. Washington is traveling across the country and last year benefitted from 7 net close losses, so look out for a close game in New Brunswick.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 28ST

Eastern Michigan by 17 over KENT ST - EM is looking for their first 4-1 start since 2016, Chris Creighton's 3rd year here. EM has covered 3 straight against Kent St and won the last two. Last year EM was -8 at home. They returned an onside kick for a td on the opening kickoff and jumped out to a 21-0 3Q lead before winning 28-14. Last week EM defeated FCS St Francis 36-0 with a 327-154 yard edge. Kent St enters 0-4 but have played a brutal schedule with losses to Pitt, Tennessee and Penn St. Their other loss came to that same St Francis team 23-17 in week two and was outgained 402-280 despite being an 18' point home favorite. QB JD Sherrord was injured last week and ex-

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pected starter Tommy Ulatowski has only attempted 7 passes thanks to a finger injury. EM is only 9-19 as a home favorite but the comparative score against St Francis is a convincing data point and Kent St has lost their last two games by a combined score of 127-0, getting outgained 1,458-179.

APPALACHIAN ST by 3 over Liberty - First meeting as FBS foes. App St is off an embarrassing 48-14 loss vs SALA at home where they allowed 474 yards (320 rush, 7.4). Liberty is off to a 4-0 start but have not yet had an impressive win (1-3 ATS) and needed a 2H comeback last week to win and cover against ECU. App St is 2-2 with two blowout losses by 46 & 34 points, and have a 2-point comeback win over the same ECU team that Liberty faced last week. App St has faced the much tougher schedule (#52 vs #128). The last time App St was a home underdog was in 2021 against Coastal Carolina (App St pulled outright upset), and the HC of that team was Chadwell and he is the coach here at Liberty. Since 2018 App St is 10-3-1 ATS as an underdog and we feel like they will make up from their poor performance last week and beat Liberty here.

EAST CAROLINA by 6 over Utsa - Second meeting. Last year in their first meeting as AAC foes East Carolina (+18') took the lead 17-14 on a 36 yd IR TD. UTSA scored the next 17 and led 31-20 at half. Up 41-20 UTSA missed a 52 yd FG then ECU scored a TD pass with :15 to get the back door cover. UTSA has dropped five straight ATS an away dog including in wk 2 at Texas St (49-10, +1) and in wk 3 at Texas (56-7, +35'). East Carolina (+7') were leading 17-7 going into half then allowed Liberty to score TDs on every possession in the 2H to fall 35-24 last week at Liberty. UTSA is 12-6 ATS on the road the last three years. The Pirates have dropped two straight and UTSA has not impressed so far so we lean with ECU here.

CLEMSON by 31 over Stanford - First meeting as Stanford travels over 2,200 miles for their 2nd straight ACC road game. Clemson has yet to play a true road game while Stanford just played at Syracuse last week but does get an extra days rest after upsetting the Orange 26-24 (+8'). Clemson was out for revenge last week against NCSt. The Tigers were -17' and led 59-14 and NCSt scored three 4Q td's for a misleading 59-35 final. Since being held to 3 points against Georgia, Clemson has put up 125 points and 1,235 yards in two games. Phil Mahaf has 284 rush (8.6). QB Klubnik has an 8-0 ratio in those two games and should take have a big day against Stanford who allows 299 pass ypg and 67%. Stanford is in their toughest stretch of travel with classes starting this week. The Cardinal are 7-16 ATS as double-digit underdogs since '17 and we will lay the points with the Tigers. We won our free Sept 5★ laying DD's against GTech in '18 (49-21, -16) and could do so again here.

NC STATE by 3 over Northern Illinois - NIU is back in their preferred role as an underdog after last week's upset loss to Buffalo. The Huskies actually led that game 14-3 2Q, only allowed 9 FD's in the entire game and finished with a 359-184 yard edge. NCSt has yet to have an impressive game. Their wins over Western Carolina and LA Tech were closer than expected and were blown out by Tennessee and Clemson. Last week NCSt trailed 59-14 at Clemson but scored 3 4Q td's in a misleading 24 point loss. RFR QB CJ Bailey made his first career start. He faces an NIU D that held Notre Dame to 296 yards and the Huskies have yet to allow 300 yards in a game. Thomas Hammock is 15-5 as an away dog while Dave Doeren is 3-10 ATS vs non-conf foes since '22. With NIU getting a full tilt we will take the underdog to keep it closer than expected.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over San Diego St - Only prior meeting was in the 2019 New Mexico Bowl where SDSSt won 48-11. SDSSt is off a bye and 2 weeks ago only trailed Cal 7-3 at the half, but lost 31-10. SDSSt is only avg'g 308 ypg through 3 games and are only avg'g 162 pass ypg. Their top offensive player has been RB Marquez Cooper 363 (5.9) and we have yet to see new HC Lewis "Flash Fast" offense in San Diego yet. CMich is 2-2 on the season but are 0-2-1 ATS against FBS teams this season. Last week they put up 527 yds but needed a td with :16 left 4Q to get past Ball St 37-34. CMich is +73 ypg on the season but are -7 TO's on the season. SDSSt has struggled to stop the run vs FBS teams, giving up 237 (4.6) and 275 (6.5) and here face a CMich team that just ran for 335 yds (10.2) last week. With no real strong angles pointing us in either direction we'll call for this game to finish right at the line.

WAKE FOREST by 7 over Louisiana - First meeting. WF has won their last 15 non-conf home games when favored. The Deacons are fresh off a bye and have lost two straight. Louisiana allowed a defensive td and KR td last week against Tulane and lost 41-33 (+1'). The Cajuns allowed 272 rush (5.8) and have a tough task against WF's Demond Claiborne (241, 4.9). QB Hank Bachmeier has a 4-0 ratio. WF led UVA by 13 earlier this year but lost after allowing two late td's. WF is only laying a fg at home and they desperately need a win for bowl hopes. LA is 0-3 SU/ATS in road games vs Power-4 foes since '21. We will give WF a td edge.

JAMES MADISON by 14 over Ball St - First meeting as FBS foes. JMU is off a 70-50 win at North Carolina where they gained and allowed 600+ yards, while Ball St nearly upset CMich on the road last week, allowing a late 4Q to lose by 3 points. Prior to last week's game, JMU's offense really hadn't shown much in their F/2 games but they ran for 223 yds (5.7) and QB Barnett threw for 388 and he has a 7-1 ratio. Ball St is 0-2 against FBS teams, but two weeks ago lost to Miami, FL 62-0 where they allowed 750 yds and only gained 115 yds. QB Semonza has a solid 7-2 ratio and is hitting 70% and JMU showed last week their defense is capable of giving up big plays. While we feel like JMU is the better team, the line is around 3 td's and we don't feel like JMU is 3 td's better than Ball St.

North Carolina by 10 over DUKE - NC has won five straight meetings in this series though Duke covered the last two. This is the first time NC has been a dog vs Duke since '18 when they were +8' and only lost 42-35. The dog is 14-8 ATS in this series with 6 outright upsets since '02. NC entered last week 3-0 and were -10' at home vs JMU. The Heels gave up 53 points and 418 yards in the 1H, plus gave up a blocked punt td, pick-6 and JMU got a surprise onside kick which led to another td. Jacoby Criswell looks like the clear starter after throwing for 475 and 3 td's last week. This is Duke's fourth 4-0 start since '14 but they haven't reached 5-0 since 1994. Last week Duke beat Middle Tenn 45-17 (-14') but only finished with a 340-295 yd edge, scoring on td drives of just 20, 1, 24 and 14. NC has won 14 of the last 17 trips to Durham yet come in as the underdog. Manny Diaz is just 8-16 ATS when favored vs FBS foes, suffering 8 outright upsets. Series history and the angles both favor North Carolina so Go Heels.

OHIO by 17 over Akron - Ohio has won the last 6 meetings SU but only have covered 3 of those games. Last season Ohio (-14) trailed 14-3 at HT but shutout Akron in the 2H and came back to win 25-14 in the season finale. Ohio started this season 2-2 with losses to Syracuse and Kentucky. Last week at UK the 'Cats were without QB Navarro (status ?) and backup Nick Poulos was just 8-19 for 110 yds & we won a 4★ LP play going against Ohio! Akron's only win so far this season was against FCS Colgate and the Zips trailed that game 17-0 in the 1Q. Their 3 losses were to Ohio St, Rutgers and S.Carolina all by 30+ points and this is also Akron's 4th road game in 5 weeks. The Zips have not fared well against the run as they are allowing 203 (5.1) and Ohio has relied on their run game this season (179, 4.8). Ohio is 17-8 ATS in MAC play under Albin and we like the 'Cats to get the win by 2+ td's.

UCONN by 10 over Buffalo - UConn had won 8 straight meetings but lost the last one back in '13 at Buffalo 41-12 (-2). Huskies are 2-2, winning both home games including last week when they crushed FAU 48-14 (-1) and finished with a 542-250 yard edge. Buffalo had just 184 yards and 9 FD's last week but rallied from down 14-3 at NIU and won 23-20. The Bulls D has held 3 of their 4 foes to a season low yards but UConn has put up the most yards that 3 of their 4 foes have allowed. We don't mind going against Buffalo off their misleading upset over NIU and Jim Mora is 10-4 ATS at home and laying less than a touchdown. Huskies probably be our Sept 5★ but we definitely like Mora's team to clear the line.

MIAMI, OH by 17 over UMass - Last met just last season where Miami (-7) led 28-7 at the half in a 41-28 win where they were +140 yds and Gabbert threw for 302 yds and 4 td's. This season Miami is winless with losses to N'Western, Cincy and Notre Dame and they have not scored more than 16 pts in any game. The offense is putting up just 292 ypg/8 ppg and the OL has allowed 11 sacks. The D is only allowing 286 ypg but are giving up 212 ypg (6.3) on the ground. UMass has already lost to 3 MAC schools (Emich, Toledo, Buff) and their lone win is vs an FCS team. Miami needs a win here after starting 0-3, but they are off games vs rival Cincy and Notre Dame and have a big MAC matchup against Toledo on deck so we will call for this game to finish right around the line.

UCF by 24 over Colorado - First meeting. Colorado is off an emotional win, as they got a hail mary on the final play of the 4Q to tie the game vs Baylor, then forced a fumble at the goal line in OT to get the win. UCF is off a bye, but in their last game at TCU, they trailed 28-7 3Q before outscoring TCU 28-6 and winning on a td with :36 left 4Q. Last season when Colo was off an emotional win, they went to Oregon the next week and lost 42-6. While UCF isn't on par with that Oregon team, they are still a very talented team and are running for 376 ypg (6.8). UCF also has a solid pass defense (#47) and with their talented DLine should be able to get pressure on QB Sanders, as Colo has allowed 16 sks incl 8 last week. UCF has a huge situational edge with being off a bye, now getting this game at home where they are 17-4 SU since 2021 and CU is just 2-5 ATS since '22 off a SU win. CU also struggles on the road as they were -154 ypg LY and this ssn lost 28-10 at Nebraska. We think those road struggles for CU continue here & like UCF big.

MARSHALL by 10 over Western Michigan - Former MAC foes meet for the 35th time, but first meeting since 2004! Both teams enter this game 1-2 with losses coming to Power 4 teams and a win each against an FCS school. Both teams played Ohio St and WMich lost 56-0 in a game where they gained 99 total yards and had just 6 FD's while Marshall led 7-0 1Q and trailed just 28-14 HT in an eventual 49-14 loss where the Herd had 264 yards and 18 FD's. Both teams allowed OSU to run the ball at will, as WMich allowed 273 (7.0) and MU allowed 280 (6.9). Former NTex and Abilene Christian QB Stone Earle is starting for MU while WMich is starting QB Wolff and he has a 3-2 ratio. The Herd are just 5-11 ATS as a home favorite, but MU has the big edge on defense (#57 vs #125) and with the line just over a FG we think the Herd get the DD win.

BOWLING GREEN by 7 over Old Dominion - First meeting. BG is just 1-2 on the season but have played both Penn St and Texas A&M to within a td. BG has gained 396 ypg on offense and their OL has only allowed 2 sacks. BG's offense is led by veteran QB Bazalak and TE Fannin (25 rec, 349 yds). ODU's offense has only put up 295 ypg this season and their defense has allowed 450+ yds each of the L/2 gms but they have a knack of hanging around in games. BG does have their MAC opener on deck, but it is only Akron so this is no real lookahead spot here. BG does have the edge on offense (#56 vs #109), defense (#60 vs #82), and ST's (#19 vs #95). However 14 of ODU's last 17 games have been decided by 7 points or less, so we will call for Bowling Green to win here, but only by a td.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 10 over Western Kentucky - First meeting. Last week we used BC as a 3★ Power Sweep play and a 4★ LPS. The Eagles had a chance to go up 7 early 4Q but QB Castellanos was SOD and MSU 89/18 fg then BC went 75/6 for the go ahead td and won 23-19 but failed to cover at -5. WKU has won 3 straight. Last week WKU DB Devonte Mathews intercepted two passes in the EZ in the final 1:30 to beat Toledo 26-21 (+2). BC QB Castellanos has a 10-2 ratio but has only rushed for 112 (2.6) in Bill O'Brien's offense after rushing for over 1,100 yards (5.2) last year. BC is laying nearly 2 td's and are off a big win with an ACC game on deck. Our lean is with the underdog Toppers who are 11-6 ATS as an away dog.

Nebraska by 20 over PURDUE - The Cornhuskers have the slight edge since joining the Big 10, 6-5 in the series. Last time here in '22, Purdue (-14) racked up 608 yards of offense and pulled out a 43-37 win. Last year Nebraska (-1) went into the 4Q with the 24-0 lead but allowed a FR TD then a rush TD but were able hold on for a 31-14 win. Nebraska is coming their conference opener where they traded blows with Illinois and fell in OT 31-24. HC Rhule is 10-5 ATS but last the Huskers were just 1-4 SU on the road. Purdue (+2) rushed for 263 but passed for 58 yds (lowest since '10) falling to Oregon ST 38-21. Purdue has struggled as a home dog with a 10-21 ATS record L/10 yrs and have not covered a game since their outright upset vs Michigan St in '21. Nebraska has looked good on both sides of the ball so we will take them to win big here on the road.

Florida St by 3 over SMU - This is SMU's first ACC game and they host last year's ACC Champs. The 'Noles started 0-3 and beat Cal 14-9 (-2), easily cashing a 4★ LP Totals play for us on Under 44'. FSU has been held under 300 yards in all four games this season. Their Oline has given up 11 sacks but did get All ACC LT Robert Washington back last week and could get two more starters back from injury this week. Last week SMU only had 375 yards but got a fumble ret td, a pick 6 and a PR td, putting up a misleading 66 points and beat TCU by 24 despite being -105 yards. The Mustangs had their 9 game home winning streak broken two weeks ago by BYU and FSU has won their last 7 true road games. We think FSU's win last week was huge for their confidence and they will play pressure free as an underdog so this look like a possible outright upset.

KANSAS ST by 17 over Oklahoma St - The home team in this series is on a 5-1 SU/6-0 ATS run. Both teams are off a loss. KSt lost at BYU 38-9 but they had the yds edge but gave up a PR td, a fumble ret td and threw an int which led to a td. Okla St loss 22-19 but trailed 22-3 before 2 late td's made the game closer but they were -171 yds. Okla St is struggling to stop the run, as they are allowing 180 ypg (4.5) but against 2 P4 this season they have allowed 232 (4.9) and 249 (4.8). KSt's rush offense has been their strong point in '24 as they are avg'g 240 ypg (6.5) led by RB Giddens (417, 6.1) and QB Johnson (267, 6.7). KSt is also stopping the run well (83, 2.8) and Okla St RB Gordon only has 236 (3.3) through 4 gms. The Wildcats are an incredible 12-2 ATS in home games vs B12 teams since 2020, and the avg win is by 26 pts. With KSt and Okla St both off misleading finals, we think KSt is the much stronger team & like them by over 2 td's!

KANSAS by 3 over Tcu - TCU has won 10 of the 11 meetings SU as B12 foes but KU is 7-3-1 ATS (all as an underdog) as the Jayhawks are the favorite in this series for the 1st time! KU is off to a 1-3 start, but all 3 losses were by 6 points or less and in every game KU held a lead. KU is led by RB Neal (443, 6.2) but QB Daniels is only hitting 56% and has a 4-7 ratio. TCU is off a misleading loss to rival SMU, as they were beat 66-42, but 3 of SMU's td's were DEF/ST's td's. TCU actually had the yds edge 480-375 and QB Hoover threw for 396! The last 2 games TCU's run D has allowed 289 (5.4) and 238 (5.7) and now are facing one of the top RB's in the country, plus a QB who has great mobility. KU has a great duo at CB in Bryant/Dotson and they are only allowing 175 pass ypg (54%) and have the #36 pass D. This KU team is better than their 1-3 record, and with a good crowd expected at Arrowhead we like KU to come away with the win.

TULANE by 7 over Usf - Since dropping their first meeting in '17, Tulane has won 3 straight in the series (4-0 ATS). Last time here was in '21, Tulane (-5) outgained the Bulls 501-297 and won lone FBS game of the year 45-14. Since that win the Green Wave are 25-8 SU. Last meeting was in '22, USF (+12) only were trailing 31-24 going into the 4Q but allowed two TDs and couldn't complete the comeback falling 45-31. USF has been historically bad on the road going 3-22 the last four year but did get a win at Southern Miss two weeks ago (49-24, -12). USF has hung around in the 1H against Bama (14-6) and Miami, FL 22-15 but have been outscored 56-10 in the second half. Tulane HC Sumrall is 14-2 SU at home so we expect them to win but our lean is right at the line.

UTAH by 21 over Arizona - Utah is playing with legit revenge here as they were beat 42-18 last season at Ariz. The Utes were w/o QB Rising last week (? here, check status) but true frosh QB Wilson got the start, and while he threw 2 int's, he got his feet wet in a big game and now is playing at home with a start under his belt. Ariz is off a bye and they have been a bit disappointing this season, as they all'd 39 pts to NMex in the opener, only beat an FCS tm by 12, then lost by 24 at KSt. Utah has ran for 206 ypg (4.9) led by RB Bernard (456, 6.9) and in their last game Ariz let up 235 ypg (5.7). Ariz does have QB Fifta and WR McMillian, but the Utes have the #3 pass D and overall have a solid edge on defense (#5 vs #64). Ariz is still without RB Croskey-Merritt, who was expected to be a big part of the offense. Utah is holding tms to 101 ypg under their avg (#19). Utah is 26-12 ATS as a HF since 2017 and we think the Utes take care of business here.

BOISE ST by 14 over Washington St - WSU has won 5 of the 6 meetings all-time. Last met in 2017 in Pullman where WSU trailed 31-10 4Q but scored 3 td's in the final 8 minutes to tie the game & won it 47-44 in OT. Boise is off a bye and are 2-1 on the ssn with a near upset of Oregon on the road. Boise is led by RB Jeanty who has ran for 586 yds (10.5, 9 td) in 3 gms. Boise's defense also has 12 sks on the ssn and are allowing just 132 rush ypg. WSU escaped San Jose St last week 54-52 in OT. The Cougs are avg'g 515 ypg and 46 ppg led by QB Mateer who has an 11-4 ratio and is also their leading rusher (425, 7.5, 5 td). WSU has done okay vs the run (151, 4.8) but struggle vs the pass as they allow 320 ypg (63%). WSU struggled with a lesser MW team and now face the top MW team on the blue turf. We like the Broncos to win by 2 td's.

Texas St by 3 over SAM HOUSTON - This game is being played at NRG Stadium, home of the Houston Texans. Texas St holds a 50-37-5 series edge but they haven't met since 2011. These two were conference rivals in the Lone Star, Gulf Star and Southland Conferences. Texas St gets a few days extra rest from their 31-28 loss to Arizona St last week. The Bobcats did hold a 400-347 yard edge and led 28-21 3Q. SH has been a mild surprise in their 3-1 start with wins over Rice, Hawaii and NMST. The Bearkats have played a game at NRG Stadium each year since 2010. SH is 18-6 ATS as an underdog under KC Keeler. They haven't lost a game by more than 10 points to a non-p5 member since their last year in the FCS and they are getting over a touchdown so our lean is with the underdog Bearkats.

UAB by 3 over Navy - First trip to Birmingham in this series. Last year Navy (+2) lead 7-6 at half and pulled away with three 4Q TDs to win 31-6. Navy has covered 4 straight ATS in road openers including 2 outright upsets at ECU in '22 (23-20, +16') and Tulane in '20 (34-30, -6'). Navy (+9) let up 659 yards to Memphis but thanks to 3 TDs before half and then scored 3 TDs within 4 possessions to pull off the upset 56-44. UAB has not allowed a TD pass all year and is coming off a bye so they have had time to prepare to shutdown the Triple Option. UAB is 13-5 SU at home (1-13 away) in the last three years so we will take the Blazers coming off a bye to get the win at home.

MEMPHIS by 35 over Middle Tennessee - Middle Tennessee leads this series 16-10-1 but haven't met since '14, a 36-17 (+13) loss. Memphis is on 25-1 SU non-conference run including a (+6) upset win at FSU 2 wks ago where they outgained the 'Noles 337-238 and had the 19-11 first down edge. LW the Tigers dropped their conference opener to Navy (-9') despite putting up 659 yds, 56-44. Middle Tenn is coming off a home loss to Duke where they were -3 in TOs and lost 45-17 (+14'). Middle Tenn has failed to cover a game this year (0-4 ATS) and its 0-3 vs FBS foes, AVG loss by 35. Memphis is 5-1 ATS as a 20+ favorite. Memphis WR #1 Taylor is ? (check status) for this game but the Tigers will handle business as they are 6-2-1 ATS coming off a SU loss.

TEXAS by 41 over Mississippi St - Texas' welcome to the SEC should be a breeze as the Longhorns are favored by 38' points. Longhorns are 4-0 and have allowed just 22 points this season. Arch Manning made his first career start last week and threw for 258 yards but did throw 2 int's in Texas' 51-3 win over ULM. Longhorns are 4-0 ATS while Miss St is 0-3 ATS vs FBS. Last week the Bulldogs lost at home to Florida 45-28 (+6'). Miss St also lost to Toledo by 24 at home two weeks ago. QB Blake Shapen had an 8-1 ratio but is OFY so they are starting true frosh Michael Van Buren. Last year we cashed our Sept 5★ going against Miss St in their loss to South Carolina. Miss St is 2-11-1 ATS as a double-digit dog since '18 and 4-15 SU/5-13-1 ATS vs teams ranked in the top 15. Texas has their bye on deck so no reason to hold back.

BAYLOR by 7 over Byu - 5th meeting, but first as conference foes. Last met here in '21 where Baylor (-5) led 17-7 HT (305-135 yd edge) and won 38-24. Since '21 BYU is just 3-6 ATS as a road underdog and failed to cover 4 of their 5 as a road dog in B12 play last season. The Cougs are 4-0 but are off a misleading final last week as they beat Kansas St 38-9 despite putting up just 241 yds as they had a pick-six, a punt return td, and 2 short td drives off of TO's. Baylor is off a tough loss at Colorado where they allowed a hail mary td on the final play 4Q to tie the game then fumbled at the goal line & lost in OT. Baylor did hold their F/3 foes to under 300 yds and last week got 8 sacks. BYU is struggling to run the ball (136, 4.0) and are facing a tough Dave Aranda defense. We think Baylor rebounds off a tough loss and gets the home win by a td.

Georgia Southern over GEORGIA ST - These in-state rivals meet for the 11th time with GSt holding a 6-4 SU lead (5-4-1 ATS). Last season GSthrn (-15') scored 27 straight points tied 7-7 to get the big lead and won 44-27 to snap a 3 game losing streak to the Panthers. GSt entered '24 as one of the least exp'd teams in the nation and after a loss to GT in the opener, have won their LJ2 gms incl an upset at home vs Vandy. The Panthers are off a bye, while GSthrn is off a 52-13 loss at Ole Miss where they were -412 yards. GSthrn has played the tougher schedule (#41 vs #72) and have the more exp'd team and the Panthers won't really have much of a home field edge as GSthrn will bring a lot of fans with them. GSt is the favorite here, but we feel like the Eagles are the much better team as QB French has a 6-1 ratio and they have a talented WR corps. We have already won twice with the Eagles as a key selection this season with two 3★ winners and like GSthrn to go on the road and get the win by a td as our underdog POW!

LSU by 14 over South Alabama - First meeting. LSU has won their last 3 vs SBC members including over Georgia St 56-14 (-31'). Tigers have won 3 straight but not impressively. They allowed 295 yards against Nicholls in week 2, trailed 17-0 before a late rally at South Carolina and only beat UCLA 34-17 (-21'). South Alabama is 2-2 and have won their last two by a combined score of 135-24. Last week SA was +7 yet upset App St 48-14. QB Gio Lopez has thrown for 843 with a 9-0 ratio in 3 games (missed loss vs Ohio) and true frosh RB Fluff Bothwell avg 9.7 ypc (359 rush). LSU is 0-4 ATS this year. Their defense has allowed 359 ypg and 6 ypg more than their foes avg, plus they just lost their star LB Harold Perkins for the season. SA is getting more than 3 td's and LSU's largest win was by just 23 points against FCS Nicholls. Last year SA beat OKSt 33-7 and they only lost by 1 point at UCLA in '22. We think they can score enough to stay within 2 td's here.

RICE by 7 over Charlotte - Fourth straight meeting. Charlotte leads the series 2-1 SU/ATS. Last time in Houston '22, Rice (+15') let up their most yards and points in conference play falling to the 49ers' 56-23. Last year was a different story as Charlotte (+3) was held to a season low 158 yards and Rice RB Dean Connors went for 184 to guide the Owls to a 28-7 win. The Owls are 3-0 SU/ATS in conference home openers. Rice (+7) faced the Triple Option LW and let up 288 yards on the ground losing 37-14. Charlotte let up 52 points and were gashed for 222 rush yds at Indiana. Charlotte HC Poggi is 6-2 ATS as an Away Dog and Rice HC Bloomgreen is 5-10 ATS as Home Favorite. Neither team has been impressive so we will put this matchup right at the line.

Oklahoma by 6 over AUBURN - OK is making their first trip to Jordan-Hare in their first ever SEC road game. Sooners will have a new starting QB after benching Jackson Arnold last week in their 25-15 loss at Tennessee. Michael Hawkins came in with a 22-3 deficit and led OK on two 4Q td drives. Aub is -8 TO's in their two losses to Cal and Arkansas. Last week Auburn had a 431-334 yard edge but lost 24-14 (-2). RfR QB Hank Brown threw 3 int's and was benched. Peyton Thorne came in and threw for 213 but he also threw 4 int's in their week 2 loss to Cal. Sooners D has held 3 of their first 4 foes to their season low yards. Aub is 3-17 SU vs ranked teams and Hawkins brought some needed juice to Oklahoma's offense. Boomer Sooner gets the win by six.

TROY by 7 over ULM - Troy has won and covered 4 of the last 5 games. These teams met last season and Troy (-21') led 21-0 HT and 31-7 into the 4Q in a 45-14 win despite only being +37 yards. However both of these teams are in a different place this season as Troy only returned 4 str's and has a new HC, as does ULM. Troy got their first win of the season a week ago vs Florida A&M 34-12 (507-343) where QB Crowder threw for 295 and 4 td's and WR Ross had 11 rec for 229 yds and 3 td. ULM got off to a 2-0 start but last week at Texas were held to 111 yds in a 51-3 loss. ULM held their F/2 foes to under 300 yds and had 7 sks in those gms. QB Booty has just 233 pass yds and ULM topped 200 rush yds in each of their F/2 gms. It is tough to trust either team in this scenario and we will be this game right at the line.

NORTH TEXAS by 14 over Tulsa - Tulsa leads the series 17-8 and have won each matchup in Denton since 1969. Tms met for the 1st time as AAC foes last year. North Texas (-2) had the slight edge in yards at half (290-282) but were tied at 21. NT opened up the 2H with back-to-back touchdown possessions and we able to hang onto a 35-28 win. Tulsa is just 18-41 SU on the road the L/10 yrs. NT is on a 7-0 ATS run as a single digit favorite including last week vs Wyoming. NT (-7) had the 334-195 yd edge and were up 27-17 at half then shut out the Cowboys in the 2H winning 44-17. Tulsa (+3) went on the road at LA Tech and pulled out a OT win 23-20. Tulsa is on a 17-3-2 ATS run as a road dog but we are impressed with NT and call for the Green to win by 2 td's.

Oregon by 31 over UCLA - Former Pac-12 rivals meet for the first time as Big-10 foes. Oregon has won 15 of last 18 SU (12-6 ATS). Last time in the Rose Bowl '21, Oregon trailed 14-0 2Q but rallied to win 34-31. Last meeting was in '22, UCLA (+6') gave up 545 yds in a 45-30 loss. Oregon HC Lanning is 9-2 ATS on the road and fresh of a bye. The Ducks had two close calls in the 1st two weeks, Idaho 24-14 and Boise St 37-34 but blew out Oregon St 49-14 two weeks ago. UCLA has struggled to move the ball on the ground, just AVG'ing 43 YPG. LW the Bruins were -10 FD's and fell at LSU, 34-17. The over has hit in the last four meetings (AVG line 64). Oregon put their struggles behind them last week so we expect them to win big in Pasadena.

Texas A&M by 7 over Arkansas - A&M is 11-1 SU in this series including a 34-22 (-6') win last year. Aggies have won 3 straight. Last week A&M was -22' and only beat Bowling Green 26-20 but that same BG team only lost 34-24 at Penn St in week 2. Marcel Reed has a 4-0 ratio and has rushed for 217 (6.8) though Connor Weigman could return from injury this week. A&M has rushed for 256 (5.9) ypg. HC Sam Pittman is 18-9-1 as a dog and just led the Hogs to an upset win over Auburn where they were +4 TO's and won 24-14 despite getting outgained 431-334. Two weeks ago Ark had to rally from down 17-3 and beat UAB. QB Taylen Green is hitting just 50% with a 2-4 ratio vs FBS foes. RB JaQuinden Jackson leads the SEC with 472 (6.8) but faces an A&M D that held their last two foes under 100 rush yards. HC Elko has a great defensive mind and will come up with a gameplan to slow down the Ark running game. A&M has the edge in all 3 phases so they get the call by a touchdown.

NOTRE DAME by 10 over Louisville - UL and ND meet for fourth time since '14. Last year UL was +6' and pulled the upset 33-20 thanks to a +4 TO edge. UL beat GTech last week 31-19 but was outgained 31-19. The Cards led 24-19 when they blocked a 4Q fg and returned it 55 yards for a td. UL also recovered a fumble in the end zone. QB Tyler Shough has an 8-0 ratio but faces a Notre Dame pass D that is allowing just 43% and is #2 in our pass D efficiency rankings. The Irish bounced back from their loss to NIU by crushing Purdue 66-7 then last week wore down Miami, OH for a 28-3 win. HC Brohm is 29-19-1 as an underdog with 17 outright upsets. However, ND is 12-2 ATS vs the ACC and we think the Irish get revenge.

SERIES PLAY OF THE WEEK.....NEW MEXICO ST SITUATION PLAY OF THE WEEK.....UAB REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK.....NOTRE DAME

PENN ST by 17 over Illinois - Penn St leads the series 21-6. Last time in Beaver Stadium ('21) these two made history by playing the longest game in college football history, 9 OT's. Illinois (+24) had the 26-14 FD edge and outgained the Nitanny Lions 395-227 to win 20-16. Last year Ill QB Altmyer was benched after throwing 4 INTs, PSU scored 20 pts of TOs and won 30-13. The Nitanny Lions are 9-2 SU but only 2-9 ATS when hosting the Illini since '97. LW Penn St put up the most yards in school history, 718, in a 56-0 win vs Kent. Illinois (+7) went into Lincoln LW and pulled off the road upset win in OT, 31-24. Both QBs have been stellar as PSU's Allar has a 8-1 ratio and ILL's Altmyer has a 10-0 ratio. PSU HC Franklin is 13-4-1 as a DD B-10 favorite while UI HC Bielema is 10-3 as an Away Dog. Angles support both sides and our lean is right at the line.

MICHIGAN by 17 over Minnesota - Michigan leads the series 77-25-3 and is on a 14-2 SU/12-4 ATS run. Last year Michigan outgained the Gophers 432-169 in a 52-10 (-19) road win. Both teams ranked within our top 15 in Pass D Efficiency but Minnesota has yet to allow a passing TD this year (7 INTs) and is just allowing 99.5 YPG. The trouble with Michigan's offense has been there passing game but thanks to 296 YPG on the ground they have won their last two games. LW Mich (+4) drove down the field (10-89) and scored a GW TD vs USC. Minny (+2) got shut out in the 2H vs Iowa to fall 31-14. The over has hit 8 straight times with an AVG line of 46 (36 at PressTime). Mich is coming off a big win so we see them carrying the momentum into this week. Long ago we cashed our Free September 5★ going with Michigan in this rivalry and the Wolverines will be back in the mix this week.

USC by 10 over Wisconsin - Wisconsin won the previous meeting 23-21 (+3) in the Holiday Bowl in '15 (last mtg '66). First Big-10 home game for the Trojans. USC is 46-16 at home the L/10 yrs but is just 3-10 ATS as a conference home favorite the L/3 ssns. Wisconsin is coming off a bye were HC Fickell 10-6 SU and the previous week played Alabama. The Badgers (+16) QB Van Dyke went down during the first drive with an ACL but they were only down 14-3 late into the 2Q, gave up a 2-73 drive with :19. The Tide pulled away with a 42-10 win. USC HC Riley is 1-5 ATS coming off a loss. Wisconsin has a 9.4% sk rate and is only allowing 160 ypg through the air so we expect them to keep it within the line in the Coliseum.

FIU by 4 over Louisiana Tech - LT is 5-1 SU in this series but FIU has covered the last 2. FIU pulled the upset as 6 pt dogs LTH in '22, winning 42-34. Two weeks ago LT led NCSt 17-6 at half and only lost by 10 but last week they were -2' at home vs Tulsa and lost 23-20. LT was -3 TO's and held to a ssn low 284 yards. QB Jack Turner was benched for true frosh Evan Bullock who threw for 49 yards and a td. FIU is 1-3 and looking to bounce back after losing to FCS Monmouth 45-42. QB Keyone "Lights Out" Jenkins threw for 362 and has an 8-4 ratio this year. LT is just 1-13 SU/3-10 ATS on the road under Cumbie. FIU already has one home upset this year when they beat CMich 52-16 in week 2. With LT's road struggles we will go with the Panthers to pull the upset.

ALABAMA by 3 over Georgia - Georgia is making just their 2nd trip to Tuscaloosa since '07. Bama is a home dog for the first time since Nick Saban's first year, 2007. Tide are 3-0 ATS this year and fresh off a bye. UGA dominated Clemson in the 2H of their opener but was unimpressive two weeks ago at Kentucky in a 13-12 win. The Bulldogs finished with just 262 yards. Bama has the edge at the skill positions with an elite WR corps led by 17 year old true frosh Ryan Williams. who has 285 and 28.5 ypc! UGA would love to get back injured DLine starters Mykel Williamson and Warren Brinson. Bama held UGA to a season low 321 yards in the SEC Title game last season. The Tide's pass D is #1 in our pass D efficiency ratings, allowing just 116 pass ypg (52%, 1-2). Tough to go against Kirby Smart but the dog is 9-3 ATS in the series with 6 outright upsets and we like what we see from DeBoer's squad so far.

New Mexico by 3 over NEW MEXICO ST - NM leads the Rio Grande Rivalry 73-35-5 but NMSSt has won the last two meetings and are 7-1 ATS in this series. NM is 0-4 but their offense has been impressive, putting up 432 ypg and 129 ypg more than their foes allow on average (#10 in FBS). Unfortunately their D is allowing 511 ypg and 64 ypg more than their foes allow on avg (#121 in FBS). NMSSt's new HC Tony Sanchez is an Aggie alum and no stranger to this rivalry. The Aggies have lost 3 straight but did nearly upset Liberty in their last home game as 22' point dogs. NM is winless yet laying nearly double-digits on the road. We think this ends much closer and series history is on our side.

Ohio St by 31 over MICHIGAN ST - The Buckeyes are 37-15 in the series while being on a 7-0 SU/ATS run. Last time in East Lansing where the Buckeyes are 9-0 SU/8-1 ATS s/99, Ohio St (-27) outgained Michigan St 614-202 and held the Spartans to just 7 rush yds in a 49-20 win. Last year the Spartans were once again outgained 530-182 and lost 38-3 (+31') loss. Michigan st is 1-11 SU/2-10 ATS vs Top 10 teams s/19. OSU (-39') outgained Marshall 569-264 in a 49-14 win last week. The Spartans (+5) held a 19-16 lead in the 4th but gave up a GW TD with 1:28 left falling to BC 23-19. NYG went to CLE last week and got a victory as QB Jones threw for 236 yds and rookie WR Nabers had 2 td grabs. The DAL defense has struggled the past 2 weeks, allowing 432 yds and 456 yds and have just 1 sack the L/2 gms. NYG is only avg'g 288 ypg on offense and were shutdown most of the 2H last week.
