4★ COLORADO ST over San Jose St - CSU is 4-1 SU/ATS against SJSt since 2014. Off their bye week CSU played their best game of the season at Oregon St, as their offense put up 439 yds and 31 pts in an OT loss, but were impressive in Reser Stadium. SJSt moved to 4-1 on the season with a 35-31 win against Nevada, where the offense put up 441 yds, but QB Brown was just 12-28 passing and the Spartans turned to backup Walker Eget. CSU RB Morrow has had B2B 100-yd games and last week ran for 140 (5.6) and WR Horton looks 100% and had 9 rec for 158 yards and SJSt's pass D gave up 390 to Wash St and 226 to Nev. CSU also has the edge on ST's (#82 vs #122) and have faced the tougher schedule (#83 vs #125). CSU is currently a home dog and HC Norvell is 10-6 ATS in that role. We've won our last four 4★'s in Power Sweep and we think the wrong team is favored here so Colorado State gets the call!

FORECAST: COLORADO ST by 13

3★ Cincinnati over UCF - Former AAC foes, noe Big 12 foes and UCF has won 5 of the past 8 meetings SU. UCF is off a 24-13 loss at Florida, where they only put up 273 yds and that was a week after they were beat at home by Colorado 48-21 despite having a 461-418 yd edge (-3 TO's). Cincy is off a bye week, and they are 3-2 on the season with both losses by a combined 5 points. Two weeks ago they lost at Tex Tech 44-41 but did put up 555 yds. CIN did lose RB Kiner (413, 6.2 in '24) in that game, but appears to be good to go here. CIN QB Sorsby is having a good season, hitting 66% with a 12-1 ratio. UCF does have the #95 pass defense as they are allowing 70% completions. UCF has had several players opt to redshirt and transfer and there may be issues within that program. Cincy has been winning for us this season, and fresh off a bye we like the Bearcats to go on the road and get the win and they are a slight dog as of presstime. **FORECAST: Cincinnati by 10**

3★ Toledo over BUFFALO - Toledo is 5-4 SU/3-6 ATS vs Buffalo since '03 but the favorite is 8-1 SU/6-3 ATS in this series. Last year Toledo was -15', they got a 97 yd KR td and a 71 yd td run and led 24-7 H then went 12 yards/1 play td after a blocked punt. Toledo won 31-13. Buffalo is fresh off a bye but two weeks ago they were trounced by UConn 47-3 (+6'). The Bulls signature win came three weeks ago when they upset Northern Illinois but they trailed that game 14-3 at half, were outgained 359-184 and were -15 FD's. We cashed a 2H play on Toledo in their upset win at Miss St earlier this year. Last week the Rockets got revenge for their MAC Title game loss when they beat Miami, OH 30-20 (-6). QB Tucker Gleason has a 13-4 ratio. The Rockets run D is allowing just 88 rush ypg (2.8). Buffalo's offense averages just 254 ypg and are putting up 104 ypg less than their foes allow on average (#126 in FBS). They've been held under 200 yards in B2B games. Rockets also have a big ST's edge (#6 vs #81). The Rockets have already beat an SEC team on the road this year so they won't be intimidated and we have them winning by more than 2 td's. **FORECAST: TOLEDO by 21**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ BYU over Arizona - Last met in the 2021 season opener in Las Vegas, where BYU won 24-16 despite being outgained 425-369. BYU is off a bye week and enters this game 5-0 SU/ATS. Two weeks ago at Baylor jumped out to a 21-0 lead 1Q and led 31-14 HT but allowed BU to come back & cut it to 34-28 and held on to win by that score. BYU has gotten good QB play from Jake Retzlaff (61%, 11-5 ratio) and WR's Roberts and Lassiter are his top 2 targets. BYU is also allowing just 293 ypg and holding foes to 72 ypg under their season average. Ariz is off a home loss to Tex Tech where they had a 422-331 yd edge but were held to 5 FG's. Ariz does have star WR McMillian (664, 17.9) but BYU's pass D ranks #3 as they are allowing just 51% with a 3-7 ratio! BYU also stops the run well (122, 3.7). BYU is fresh off a bye and have the advantage of altitude here and a great home crowd. We'll back the Cougs to win by 2 td's!

FORECAST: BYU by 14

2★ Boise St over HAWAII - Since 2009 Boise is 8-0 SU/7-1 ATS against Hawaii and have covered 3 of the L4 trips here. Last met in 2020 on the Island and Boise (-13') led 19-3 HT and 40-17 late 3Q but Hawaii scored 2 td's 4Q to get the backdoor cover. Boise has been on a roll this season led by RB Jeanty (1031, 10.9, 16 td) and a run game that is avg'g 301 ypg (8.2). QB Madsen is hitting 63% with a 10-2 ratio and UH only has the #74 pass D. Hawaii is 2-3 on the snn, but both wins were vs FCS teams. UH is rushing for just 94 ypg (3.7) and their OL has all'd 13 sks incl 5 last week & now face a Boise pass rush that has 20 sks. Boise has the huge edge on offense (#13 vs #102) and have faced the toughest schedule (#87 vs #125). With their success overall vs Hawaii and especially on the Island, we like the Broncos, led by their star RB, to get the win here by over 4 td's. **FORECAST: Boise St by 31**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 9th

New Mexico St vs JACKSONVILLE ST - These two met in last year's regular season finale and New Mex St won 20-17 (+2') with a 455-333 yd edge. Jax St started 0-3 but has won their last two games 44-7 (-6) over SMiss and 63-24 (-16') over Kennesaw St last week. Furman transfer QB Tyler Huff is hitting 67% with a 5-4 ratio and is their #1 rusher with 445 (7.1). Gamecocks are 7-2 ATS at home since joining the FBS. NMSt has lost their last four games. They've been outgained in all 5 games and are -200 ypg. The Aggies are offense is putting up 118 ypg less than their foes allow on avg (#130 in FBS). Their defense is allowing 490 ypg in their last 4 and have allowed 277 rush (6.1) in their L4. NMSt has turned to Wake Forest transfer QB Santino Marucci but he's only hitting 48% with a 2-2 ratio. Tony Sanchez was 17-10 as an AD at UNLV but 0-2 here and the Gamecocks are on a roll with two blowout wins. Call 1-800-654-3448 or goto NCSports.com and get our Wednesday Night Marquee for \$15.

Thursday OCTOBER 10th

JAMES MADISON by 3 over Coastal Carolina - As SBC foes JMU has won both prior meetings, and they were in blowout fashion as they won 47-7 in '22 here and last season won 56-14 last season. JMU is off an upset loss to ULM where they were +142 yards but allowed a fumble return for td and lost 21-19. Coastal hosted ODU and led 21-17 HT and went up 35-17 3Q then led 45-30 4Q in a 45-37 win. CC QB Vasko is off his best game of the season, throwing for 367 yds & 3 td and the offense is rushing for 197 (4.7) while the OL has allowed just 2 sacks. CCU is 9-5 ATS as an away dog since 2019 and have pulled 4 outright upsets. JMU is still 4-1 on the season and are playing well, but given the fact they are over a td favorite against a good CC team has us leaning with the underdog in this matchup.

LOUISIANA TECH by 10 over Middle Tennessee - The home team has won the last 6 meetings. Last year MT was -3 and won 31-23 despite getting outgained 419-353. Both teams are looking for their first win over an FBS foe. LT opened with a home win over Nicholls but has lost their last 3. They did lead NCS 17-6 at half with a 202-117 yd edge in a 10 pt loss and their other two losses were by 10 combined points against Tulsa and FIU. Middle Tenn beat Tenn Tech by just 7 in their opener and have lost 4 straight since. None of their losses were by less than 17 points but they've faced the #49 sked while LT has only played the #112 sked. LT is at home and has a solid edge on D and ST's. Sonny Cumble has 7 wins at LT with 6 coming at home and MT has lost their last 8 road games so LT gets the call by double-digits.

WESTERN KENTUCKY by 21 over Utep - WKU has won all four meetings vs UTEP but the Miners have covered 3 of the 4 including last year when WKU won 21-13 (-9'). WKU is 3-2 and fresh of a bye. Two weeks ago they nearly upset Boston College who was playing with a backup QB. WKU led that game 20-7 3Q and finished with a 355-279 yd edge but a late fumble led to BC's go ahead td. UTEP is 0-5 after their 41-21 (+10') loss to Sam Houston. The Miners are -114 ypg, rushing for just 88 ypg (2.9), allowing 239 rush ypg (5.2) and 67% completions. WKU is -15 ypg but +96 in their last 4. QB Caden Veltkamp has thrown for 883 yards with an 8-4 ratio and is hitting 70%. UTEP has had good performances in all of their last 4 games while UTEP has yet to have a quality performance. We don't much of a lean here but will call for WKU to win by 3 td's.

Friday OCTOBER 11th

MARYLAND by 14 over Northwestern - Northwestern is 3-1 SU and 4-0 ATS vs Maryland. Last time here ('22), the Wildcats (+14') tied the game with 3:34 left but :12 seconds later gave up a 75-yd rush TD and lost 31-24. Maryland (-14) went down 24-17 at half but were intercepted with a chance to win with 1:25 left, losing 33-27. LW Northwestern(+13) went with QB Lausch who went 23-38 243-2-0 but were outgained 529-336 but were only down 27-24 with 11:19 left then TOD next two possessions to fall 41-24. Maryland is coming off a bye were HC Locksley is 3-8 SU. Northwestern is on a 4 straight ATS losing streak and Maryland is looking for revenge as they were upset in last year's meeting so we will go with the Terrapins by 2 td's.

Unlv by 21 over UTAH ST - Since 2012 UNLV is just 1-6 SU but 4-3 ATS against Utah St. In their last meeting UNLV was the favorite (-3) and despite being -101 yards they won 34-24 as the Rebels were +6 TO's. UNLV is off a home loss to 'Cuse in OT where they were -138 yds but did have another blocked punt td. Utah St has yet to beat an FBS team (1-4) and last week at Boise had 337 yds at HT but trailed 49-17 and lost 62-30 but did only get outgained by 92 yds. Utah St's defense is allowing 454 ypg the L4 gms and for the season are allowing 217 rush ypg (5.7) and have the #125 pass D. UNLV's offense is putting up 252 rush ypg (5.7) and QB Williams is 34-41 passing in 2 games. UNLV also has the huge ST's edge (#1 vs #108) and even with the line being close to 3 td's, we will lean with the Rebels to get the cover.

Utah by 13 over ARIZONA ST - The Utes have won and covered the L4 meetings against the Sun Devils. Last season Utah (-10') hosted Ariz St and were up 24-3 HT (+270 yds) in a 55-3 win where they held ASU to 89 total yards! Utah does enter off a bye and 2 weeks ago lost 23-10 at home vs Ariz despite having the yds edge as the Utes F/3 drives had 185 yds but only 3 points (SOD twice). ASU is off a 35-31 win over Kansas at home where they put up 485 yds, incl 313 rush (7.0). Utah does a much better job of stopping the run (107, 3.6) and they do well against the pass as their pass D is allowing just 173 ypg (48%) and ranks #2 in pass D efficiency. Utah is also holding foes to 110 ypg under their avg (#13 FBS). With a week to rest, we have to think QB Rising will be back to play, which would be a huge boost for the Utes offense and Ariz St did allow 411 yds last week. We like the Utes off a bye to get the win by almost 2 td's.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 12th

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Miami, OH - The last three meetings in this series have all been outright upsets. MU is just 1-4 this season and their only win was by 3 points at home over UMass. The Redhawks are -64 ypg and last week lost at Toledo 30-20 (+5'). QB Brett Gabbert has just a 5-7 ratio and is hitting 55%. EM is 4-1 and they beat that same UMass team on the road 28-14. The Eagles are +2 ypg and won last week at Kent St 52-33 (-14'). QB Cole Snyder has a 4-0 ratio. EM is 42-16-1 ATS as a dog since '16 and they've won 8 of their last 9 at Rynearson Stadium. Chuck Martin is 47-30-1 ATS in conference play but we can't go against Chris Creighton when his team is an underdog so we will call for the 4th straight upset in this series.

Iowa St by 7 over WEST VIRGINIA - Since 2018 ISU is 4-1 SU/ATS against WVU. Last met in '22 and ISU (-6') led just 10-7 HT but ISU scored 21 straight pts 2H and won 31-14. ISU sits at 5-0 on the season and are off a win against Baylor where they held the Bears to 178 yds and 7 pts after their F/2 drives and ISU used the momentum of a blocked punt td to outscore Baylor 37-6 after trailing 14-6 2Q to win 43-21. WVU is off a game at Okla St where they pulled the outright upset 38-14 as WVU put up 557 total yards incl 389 rush (6.0) and the defense allowed just 227 yds. However WVU's pass D has struggled at times and rank #96 in pass D, and ISU QB Becht is hitting 66% with a 9-3 ratio. ISU is also rushing for 247 ypg (5.7) the L3 games and WVU did allow 247 rush (5.3) to Kansas 2 weeks ago. This will be a close game by we side with ISU by a td here.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 3 over Marshall - As SBC foes MU has won and covered both games. Last time MU came to GSthrn they were a 7-pt underdog but pulled the upset 23-10. GSthrn is off a bye and 2 weeks ago played their best game of the season as they put up 498 total yards, including 261 rush yards (5.4) in a 38-21 win at Georgia St. This is MU's 4th straight game and last week they hosted App St, were outgained 473-365 and were -11 FD's but won the game 52-37 as MU got a pick-6 and were +2 TO's. MU did throw a curvball last week and went with QB Braylon Braxton who ran for 140 yds & 2 td's. However GSthrn now has film on that offense and can do some damage on the ground with RB's White & Arnold. GSthrn QB French also has 7-1 ratio. GSthrn plays well at home (10-4 SU/ATS since '22) and we like the Eagles to get the home upset.

California by 3 over PITTSBURGH - ACC foes meet for the first time since 1966. Pitt hasn't even hosted a team from California since 1974. The Panthers are 5-0 and ranked for the first time this season (#22). We cashed a 3★ LPS on Pitt last week in their 34-24 (-2') win over North Carolina. Eli Holstein has a 15-3 ratio but the catalyst of the offense is 175 lb RB Desmond Reid who is their #1 rusher (374, 6.0) and #2 receiver (322, 13.4) but was beat up last week with 29 touches. Cal is 3-2 and coming off B2B close losses. Last week they led Miami 35-10 3Q but lost 39-38, cashing on a 3★ on these pages as 10' pt dogs. Pitt had to make two late comebacks to beat WVU and Cincy this year. Cal's pass D leads the FBS with 11 int's. Pitt has covered all 5 games this year but Narduzzi is 17-23-1 as a HF while Justin Wilcox is 15-7 ATS as an away dog since '17 and they have a win at Auburn this year. We think Cal gets the win they just missed on last week.

KENTUCKY by 7 over Vanderbilt - Two years ago Vandy came into Lexington and ended their 26 game SEC losing streak, beating KY 24-21 (+17'). This time Vandy is actually coming off a win and their was nothing fluke about it. Vandy outgained Bama 418-394, had a 26-17 FD edge and was the more physical team, with a 166-84 rush edge. Diego Pavia threw for 252 and 2 td's in the win. KY is fresh off a bye and pulled an upset of their own over a top 10 team two weeks ago when they beat Ole Miss 20-17. The 'Cats D has held all five foes to their season low yards and hold foes 194 ypg below their avg. However KY's offense is averaging just 13 ppg in 3 SEC games. Normally we would go against a team off a program defining upset, but those teams are normally favored the following week while Vandy is still getting 2 td's. Diego Pavia is a 'prove you wrong' kind of guy and the 'Cats offense doesn't pull away from teams so our lean is with the scrappy Commodores.

NC STATE by 3 over Syracuse - NCS is won 7 of the 10 ACC meetings vs Syracuse but are only 4-6 ATS and Syracuse won 24-9 (-3') with a 389-255 yd edge last year. The home team is 5-0 ATS in this series. NCS has alternated wins with losses in each of their first six games. Last week they lost QB Grayson McCall to a concussion but Cj Bailey stepped up and had his best game, throwing for 272 yards and 2 td's but NCS lost to Wake Forest 34-30 (-3'). Syracuse scored the game tying td with :23 left then beat UNLV in OT last week 44-41. The Orange are +90 ypg and Kyle McCord has thrown for 1,814 with a 17-6 ratio and faces our #17 rated pass D (57%, 11-6). NCS is -36 ypg but they've played our #19 sked while Cuse has ply'd our #111 sked. Syracuse is ply'g their 2nd straight on the road game under new HC Fran Brown while NCS is 26-4 SU at home since '18 and getting points here. We are leaning with the underdog Wolfpack!

Missouri by 20 over UMass - Mizzou is traveling roughly 1,200 miles to play in tiny McGuirk Stadium which seats just 17K. Mizzou comes in off a 41-10 loss at Texas A&M where they were outgained 512-254. The Tigers haven't covered since week two against Buffalo when they won 38-0 (-34). UMass is 1-5 and have covered their last two, both on the road. Last week they led Northern Illinois 13-7 at half with a 191-148 yd edge but lost 34-20. The situation heavily favors UMass. Mizzou is on their 2nd straight road trip with a home game against Auburn on deck. UMass is 9-1 ATS vs the SEC while Mizzou is 1-5-1 ATS as a DD AF. With the tech angles and situation so heavily favoring UMass we will call for the underdog Minutemen to keep it much closer than expected.

BOWLING GREEN by 3 over Northern Illinois - BG has lost 4 of the L/5 meetings against NIU since 2014. Last met back in 2021 at NIU and BG (+9) got a late td 4Q to make the score 34-26 for the backdoor cover! BG is 2-3 on the season but played P4 teams Penn St & Texas A&M within a td and lost late 4Q to ODU so all 3 losses are by 1 score. BG is led by stud TE Fannin (672, 14.6) and RB Stewart (270, 5.7). NIU sits at 3-2 and are off a win against UMass. The Huskies are holding teams to 94 ypd under their season avg (#21 FBS) but have faced just the #116 schedule. NIU's OL has allowed just 5 sacks but faces a BG pass rush with 15 sacks on the season. We feel like these are 2 evenly matched teams and will call for the home team by a FG.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 10 over Akron - WM is 18-4 all-time vs Akron and have won 8 of the last 10 (7-3 ATS) but the home team is just 3-7 SU/2-8 ATS. WM is 2-3 and coming off a road win over Ball St. The Broncos (-10) led 45-35 and allowed a td with 1:47 left to cut it to 3. QB Hayden Wolff is hitting 69% with a 7-2 ratio. RB Jaden Nixon leads with 484 (7.1) and they just got back last year's top rusher Jalen Buckley from injury. Akron has looked competent in MAC play. They only trailed 14-10 at Ohio and two weeks ago they only trailed 14-10 at Ohio but lost 30-10. Akron is 5-2 as a MAC away dog. WM does seem to be getting healthier and the line is in single digits which has us going against the series home trend and leaning with the Broncos.

Louisville by 3 over VIRGINIA - UL has won the last two meetings against UVA but last year Cardinals were -20' and only won 31-24. UL is off B2B 7 point losses and were fortunate to beat GTech three weeks ago. Last week they were -7 at home vs SMU but lost 34-27. Virginia is 4-1 and off B2B wins. They smoked Coastal Carolina on the road 43-24 (-3') then last week they fell behind BC 14-3 at half, were outgained 193-116 but shutout BC in the 2nd half and won by 10. UL has played the toughest sked (#51 vs #91) and QB Tyler Shough has a 13-2 ratio while Bama transfer WR Ja'Corey Brooks leads with 489 (19.6) and 6 td's. However, UL is 0-4 as a road favorite while UVA HC Tony Elliott is 6-3 as a home dog. Give us the home team that is playing well and getting a full touchdown to cover.

TENNESSEE by 21 over Florida - Vols are out for legit revenge for last year's 29-16 (-5) loss in The Swamp. Gators are 17-2 SU/14-5 ATS against the Vols since 2005. Florida is 8-1 ATS as the underdog, with 6 outright upsets in this series. Tennessee was 4-0 SU/ATS entering last week but we went with Arkansas +14 against the Vols and cashed a 3★ LPS as the Hogs pulled the upset 19-14. Tennessee returns home where they are 15-1 SU/12-4 ATS since '22. Florida is 4-16 SU/7-13 ATS away from home since '21. They did win by 17 at Miss St earlier this year but Toledo also went into Starkville and won by 24 the week prior. Heupel's offense is able to use their tempo more at home. Florida's run D allowed 211, 6.2 on road vs 101, 3.3 at home last year and against Miss St they allowed 240 (4.3). The Vols are #5 in the nation, averaging 267 (5.7) led by Dylan Sampson (589, 6.5, 12 td's). Series history says take Florida but Heupel is 8-3 ATS off a loss here and we will take the revenge minded Vols by 3 td's.

Old Dominion by 6 over GEORGIA ST - As SBC foes the home team has won both prior meetings. ODU is off to a 1-4 start but 3 of their 4 losses are by 8 points or less. GST is off to a 2-2 start and are off a bye week. Two weeks ago they were outgained 498-385 against GStm and lost 38-21 as a home favorite. ODU did go with backup QB Colton Joseph and threw for 262 yds and 3 td's and also ran for 68 yds. ODU also ran for 200 yards (5.4) last week. GST comes in with the #101 pass defense and their defense is allowing foes to gain 67 ypd above their season average (#125 FBS). ODU has played close games with S.Car (lost by 4) and ECU (lost by 6) and only trailed VA Tech by 4 at HT, and we feel like they have superior talent to GST, who entered '24 as one of the least exp'd teams in the country. We like ODU to get the win & they are a slight dog as of presstime.

Ball St by 3 over KENT ST - Ball St has won the last two meetings including last year 34-3 (-12') with a 388-97 yard edge. Two of the worst defenses in the country meet here. Kent St is allowing 51 ppg and 583 ypd while Ball St is allowing 48 ppg and 516 ypd. Ball St's pass D is dead last in the FBS in efficiency, allowing 301 ypg, 74% with an 18-1 ratio but Kent's isn't far behind at #132, 294 ypg, 70% and a 14-4 ratio! Both teams are looking for their first win over a FBS foe. Ball St has lost their last 4 games but did cover last week at Western Michigan (+9'), only losing 45-42. Kent St is 0-5 SU/ATS but was tied in the 3Q last week at EMich. QB Tommy Ulatowski made his first start after returning from injury and threw for 345 yards and 3 td's. The home team is 8-1 SU/6-3 ATS in this series and the dog is 7-4 ATS with 5 outright upsets so our lean is with Kent St.

Clemson by 17 over WAKE FOREST - Clemson has won their last 7 in Winston Salem but are also just 3-8 ATS there. Last year the Tigers (-21) had a lackluster performance and only won 17-12 with a 338-239 yd edge. Last week Clemson (-16) led FSU 17-0 1Q but settled for 7 fg attempts, all from 38 yards or less and missed two, costing us a 4★ LPS and a 3★ Key Selection. We called Wake Forest's upset win over NCSt in these pages last week. The Deacons are 2-3 and their offense averages 431 ypg and 103 ypd more than their foes allow on average. Clemson does have big edges on offense (#9 vs #66) and defense (#28 vs #109) but WF has the ST's edge (#46 vs #76). WF is 17-6 ATS as a double-digit dog and 11-6 ATS as an ACC dog of 20+ which is right where the line sits. We will take the Deacons to keep it closer just like last year.

GEORGIA by 28 over Mississippi St - UGA has won the last 4 meetings vs Miss St including in '22, 45-19 (-16'). The home team is 5-1 ATS in this series. This is a huge sandwich situation for UGA, coming off their 31-13 win over Auburn (-21') and they have a showdown at Texas on deck. Miss St is 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS vs FBS foes. They already have lost at home to Toledo by 24 and Florida by 17. Their best performance was actually a 35-13 loss to Texas prior to their bye where they only trailed 14-6 at half but were outgained 522-294. This will be QB Michael Van Buren's 2nd career start. He was 12-23 for 144 yards at Texas. UGA is 10-19 ATS as a 20+ SEC favorite and are laying nearly 5 td's here. With the big game on deck for Georgia we would prefer to take the pts.

Ohio by 6 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - Ohio's 34-20 win LY over CMich stopped a 6-game losing streak for Ohio in this matchup. Ohio enters this matchup off a bye and 2 weeks ago only led Akron 14-10 HT but added 2 td's in 4Q to win 31-10. CMich also enters off a bye and in their last game trailed 21-13 HT over SDSt but kicked the GW fg with 5 seconds left to win 22-21. CMich has faced the #130 schedule but are avg'g 430 ypg on offense but QB Labas has a 7-7 ratio. Ohio does run the ball well (190, 4.8) led by RB Tyus (500, 5.7) and QB Navarro is #2 with 213 (4.8). Ohio gave up 488 to Kentucky & 480 vs Syracuse but in their other 3 games all'd just 241 ypd and their pass rush has 8 sks the past 3 games. We feel Ohio is the better team, but CMich is 5-1 ATS as a home dog since '19 so we'll cut our lean on Ohio off at 6 points.

North Texas by 10 over FAU - Former CUSA members meet for the first time in AAC play. FAU leads the series 8-6 SU and 9-5 ATS. Last met in '22, North Texas (+3) put up 300 yards on the ground in a 45-28 win. Last time in Baco Raton ('17) was the CUSA title game, FAU was up 27-0 H and put 632 yards winning easily 41-17. Both teams are coming off byes. North Texas' offense has been stellar TY putting up 512 YPG and 41 PPG but their D is giving up 415 and 32. FAU is averaging just 289 YPG and 18 PPG in FBS play TY. The Owls QB's have a 2-6 ratio but they are averaging 181 YPG on the ground. Both teams are coming off 3 straight overs. NT has the huge offensive edge (#22 vs #124) so we will take the Mean Green to keep it up their great play!

Utah by 10 over RICE - UTSA lost the first three in this series but have won 8 straight (6-2 ATS) since. Last time here ('22) the Roadrunners (-13) were up 28-0 H (277-104 yds) and won easily 41-7. Last year in their first game as AAC foes, Rice (+13') was only down 10-7 at H but in the 2H went Punt/gave up a PR TD/Punt/Fumble/Punt to lose 34-14. Both teams are coming off byes. Rice HC Bloomgren is 3-7 coming off a bye but is 13-7 ATS as a home dog. Rice is 0-2 ATS as a single point dog this year. UTSA is holding their foes to 2.8 yds per carry while Rice is averaging 5.9 YPC. UTSA was 9-3 as an away favorite and are 7-2 ATS as single digit favorite last three years so we will take them to win by 10 here.

ARMY by 28 over Uab - First meeting as AAC foes as teams met 5 times as CUSA foes from '00-'04, UAB 5-0. UAB is 17-29 SU and 20-25 ATS on the road since '17 including 1-4 SU/2-3 ATS in conference road openers. UAB (+18) let up their most points in a game in the programs history last week vs Tulane. The Blazers were outgained 497-305, gave up a KR TD and INT TD en route to getting blown out 71-20. Army holds the longest winning streak in the FBS with 10 straight and are 5-0 for the 1st time since 1996. Last week, Army (-14) held Tulsa to 149 yds below their ssn avg and won 49-7. Army is 5-0 ATS on the year and is averaging 361 YPG (6.8) on the ground this and are holding their foes to 260 YPG this so we go with the Knights to keep rolling!

ULM by 3 over Southern Miss - 3rd meeting as SBC foes. Last season SMiss (-3) led 17-0 HT (295-99) and won 24-7 and were +3 TO's. SMiss enters this game 1-4 on the season. Last week they hosted Louisiana and despite being -233 yds only lost 23-13. ULM is off to a 4-1 start, and are doing it with their defense as they are holding teams to 72 ypd under their season avg. However, the ULM offense has struggled, avg'g just 228 ypg over their L/4 games. ULM did make the move to QB Armenta last week in their upset win over JMU where a fumble return TD swung the momentum in their favor and they pulled the outright upset. However ULM is in an unfamiliar role as a home conf favorite, as they are 0-13-1 ATS in that role since 2014. While we think ULM is the better team, they are laying almost a full td and we don't trust them quite yet to cover that line.

ILLINOIS by 28 over Purdue - Purdue leads the series 48-46-6 and has won 7 of the last 8 while winning the last 6 in Champaign (4-2) since '12. Last time here ('22), tied 21-21 4Q, Purdue held Illinois scoreless on 3 of their 4 4Q possessions to win 31-24 (+14) win as a DD away dog. Last year (E), Illinois had the slight yards edge 200-188 at H down 16-13 but gave up 3 td's in 4 2H possessions again falling 44-19. Last week, Purdue (+11') was a DD dog for the second straight week and was outgained 589-216, were shutout while being outscored 31-0 in the 2H, losing 52-6. Illinois is coming off a bye and two wks ago lost to Penn St 21-7, HC Bielema is 39-29-2 ATS off a SU loss. Purdue is playing their 3rd road game in 4 weeks and are allowing 504.3 YPG in FBS play we will go with the Illini by 4 td's!

RUTGERS by 3 over Wisconsin - Wisconsin is 5-0 SU (3-2 ATS) vs Rutgers. Last time here ('21), Wisconsin outgained Rutgers 579-207 in a 52-3 (-13) win. Last year, Rutgers (+12) was down 24-6 with 4:42 left in the 4th caused a Wisco fumble then turn it into a touchdown to get the backdoor cover, 24-13. Wisconsin got their first ATS win of the year last week vs Purdue. The Badgers (-11) outgained the Boilermakers 589-216 in a 52-6 win. Rutgers (+7) held Nebraska to 142 yards below their season average and scored with 4:08 to go to make it 14-7 but were SOD in their final possession to lose. Rutgers is on a 5-1 run as a favorite by 3 or less but Wisconsin full of confidence of a dominate win and we would rather put this at a FG and see where the line goes.

Kansas St by 13 over COLORADO - Have not met since 2010 when they were last B12 foes. Both teams enter off a bye week. Colorado last pulled a 48-21 upset at UCF where they were outgained 461-418, but did collect 5 sacks and were +3 TO's. KSt faced Okla St 2 weeks ago in a game where they won 42-20 and ran for 300 yards (8.8) where RB Giddens ran for 187 (12.5). KSt does have the #54 pass D and they have only allowed 5 td's and have 4 int's. On the season Kansas St is rushing for 252 (6.9) and Colorado is allowing 156 (4.0) on the ground. KSt is only allowing 92 (3.0) rush and do have a good DLine that could cause havoc. Baylor almost beat Colorado here three weeks ago, and this KSt team is more talented & disciplined than them and we think the Wildcats go into Boulder and get the win by almost 2 full td's.

NEW MEXICO by 7 over Air Force - NMex is 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS against Air Force since 2018. NMex is just 1-4 on the season and 2 weeks ago picked up their first win, beating NMexSt 50-40 in a game where they put up 579 total yards incl 331 rush (6.8). Air Force has dropped 4 in a row and have yet to beat a FBS team. Last week AF allowed 463 total yds including 329 rush (6.9) in a 34-7 loss to Navy. AF is only putting up 249 ypg/11 ppg and are only avg'g 173 rush ypg (3.4) and they went to backup QB Hayes. AF's defense has not been strong like years past, as they are allowing foes to gain 40 ypd above their season avg (#101 FBS). NMex QB Dampier is hitting 57% (6-6 ratio) but does lead the team with 318 rush (7.8) and the NMex OL has yet to allow a sack through 5 games. NMex is allowing 503 ypg and 44 ppg, so we feel like AF will move the ball, but will side with the Lobos stronger offense to win by a td.

NC is better than their 3-3 record and their offense is averaging 100 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. Jacoby Criswell is a solid QB and Hampton is the best RB GT has faced. Washington St by 7 over FRESNO ST - Last meeting came in the 2022 LA Bowl where Fresno St (-4) outgained WSU 501-182 in a 29-6 win. Fresno St is off a bye week, and two weeks ago they were roughed up 59-14 at UNLV where they were -4 TO's and -104 yds. WSU also enters this game off a bye and 2 weeks ago they suffered their first loss of the season at Boise St, losing 45-24 as they allowed 276 rush yds (7.7). Fresno has allowed 450+ yards each of their L/2 games and now face a WSU offense led by QB Mateer who is hitting 58% (13-5 ratio) and is also the #1 rusher (453, 5.9). Fresno has only put up 345 and 346 yds in their L/2 games and have struggled to run the ball at times (114, 3.3) and QB Keene only has a 7-6 ratio on the season. WSU has the big offensive edge (#29 vs #75) and we think that is the difference here & like WSU by a td.

ALABAMA by 17 over South Carolina - SC is making their first trip to Tuscaloosa since 2009 when Steve Spurrier was their HC. The big question is how does Bama bounce back from their loss to Vandy? SC knows a little something about upsetting Bama from 2010 when they were +7 and beat #1 Bama 35-21. Bama hasn't looked right since they took the 28-0 lead over Georgia. They allowed 341 yards in the 2H vs Georgia and blew the lead before true frosh phenom Ryan Williams pulled off an amazing 75 yd td. SC had their chances last week at Ole Miss but couldn't convert and lost 27-3 (+9). SC's Oline has allowed 21 sacks (17.6%). Bama has 10 sacks this season including 3 vs UGA but none last week. Bama's large lead vs Georgia made them over confident and South Carolina is a scrappy team and we don't feel safe laying 3 td's with this Bama team.

NOTRE DAME by 27 over Stanford - Notre Dame leads the series 22-14 but Stanford has won the last 2 of 3 in South Bend. Last meeting here (22), Stanford ended a 11 game losing streak against FBS foes. The Cardinal had a 10-0 lead at H but allowed 2 td's in 3Q but kicked a FG with 10:20 left and held onto a 16-14 win. Last year, Notre Dame (-25") outgained Stanford 321-182 (28-16) in the 1H and ND scored on their first three drives while capping it off with a missed FG TD to win 56-23. The Irish defense is allowing 284 YPG and 125 yds below their season average while the Cardinal have been outgained in each game this year. Since ND got upset by N Illinois they have had an avg game grade of 120.8 so we will take the Irish to keep rolling here.

† Texas by 10 over Oklahoma - This is the first ever SEC version of the Red River Rivalry. Two years ago Texas won 49-0, which was the largest margin in series history but last year Oklahoma got revenge, handing Texas their only regular season loss, 34-30. Both teams are fresh off a bye. Texas is 5-0 and ranked #1. Their signature win came at Michigan in week 2, 31-12 (-6"). Oklahoma started 3-0 before losing at home to Tennessee 25-15 (+6"). The Sooners were on their way to a 2nd straight loss when LB Kip Lewis took an interception 63 yards for a td and OK beat Auburn 27-21. The Sooners offense avg just 298 ypg but true frosh Michael Hawkins was making his first start vs Auburn and has had the bye week to prep. The Sooners D is holding foes 91 ypg below their avg. Nine of the last 11 meetings have been decided by 8 points or less but Texas is laying 2 td's. We say that's too many points in this rivalry.

LSU by 3 over Ole Miss - Loser of this game will have their playoff hopes on life support. The home team is 10-2 SU and 9-1 ATS in this series. Last year Ole Miss was -2", trailed 49-40, went 65/10, 88/8 td's and won 55-49. LSU lost their opener to USC but has won 4 straight and are fresh off a bye. Ole Miss bounced back from their loss to Kentucky with a 27-3 win at South Carolina. The Rebels finished with a 425-313 yd edge and had 6 sacks (23 on the ssn). QB Jaxson Dart has a 13-2 ratio while Garrett Nussmeier has a 15-4 ratio. Ole Miss WR Tre Harris leads the nation with 885 yards (17.0). Ole Miss has the edge on D, LSU has the home edge and the Tigers have played a much tougher schedule (#25 vs #101). Tough to pick a side in this game but we will go with the home underdog and take LSU by a fg.

LOUISIANA by 14 over Appalachian St - After losing their F/8 games against App St, LA has pulled the outright upset each of the last 3 meetings. This will be just the third time LA has been favored against App St as SBC foes. App St was at Marshall last week and did have a 473-365 yd edge but were -2 TO's incl a pick-six and lost 52-37. LA moved to 4-1 with a 23-13 win over SMiss where they were +233 yds but were held to 3 short fg's so the margin of victory could have been greater. App St's defense has allowed foes to gain 58 ypg above their season avg (#113 FBS) and LA's offense is putting up 446 ypg led by veteran QB Woodriddle who is hitting 70% with a 10-3 ratio and the run game is putting up 191 (5.6) plus their OL has all'd just 5 sks in 7 games. App St has had issues stopping the run (218, 5.9) and they have the #130 pass defense. This Cajuns offense can be explosive & at home we like them to get the win by 2 td's.

WYOMING by 3 over San Diego St - SDSt has won 4 of the L/5 meetings dating back to 2012. They have not met since 2019 where SDSt (-3.5) got the win 26-22 on a late td pass. WY is off a bye week & 2 weeks ago they picked up their first win of '24 vs Air Force. They trailed 13-7 HT but outscored AF 24-6 2H to win 31-19. SDSt opened MW play last week with a win over Hawaii where they got the go-ahead td mid 4Q and held on to win 27-24. SDSt is only putting up 322 ypg and their best offensive player is RB Cooper who has 583 yds (4.6). In their last game WY QB Svoboda had his best game of '24, hitting 15-21 for 165 plus ran for 70 yards and RB Scott had 97 (5.1). In their L/4 games SDSt has allowed 425 ypg and are going to the altitude of Wyoming. Since 2019 WY is 8-2 ATS when they are a home dog & have pulled 6 outright upsets & we like WY to get the outright win here.

TEXAS ST by 17 over Arkansas St - TXSt has won 3 of the L/4 meetings SU but failed to covered each of the L/2 meetings. Last season TXSt had a 539-487 yd edge in the game but Ark St had 2 pick-6's, a fumble return td and a KR td in a 77-31 Ark St win. TXSt is off a 38-17 at Troy last Thur where the offense put up 467 yds and QB McCollum threw for 252 yds & 3 td's. Their defense overall is holding foes to 39 ypg under their season average, and their pass rush has 19 sks on the season including 6 sks a week ago. Ark St comes into this game with the #91 pass D and are also allowing 219 rush ypg (5.8) and are giving up 36 ypg more than their foes allow (#107 FBS). QB Raynor is also hitting just 59% and has a 4-5 ratio and TXSt has only allowed opposing QB's to hit 53%. Ark

St showed life last week vs SAAla (411 yds) but here they face an explosive offense and we like the Bobcats to get the home win by over 2 td's.

Minnesota by 3 over UCLA - First meeting since 1978 and teams are separated by 1,908 miles which is Minnesota's longest road trip since Hawaii in '97. The Bruins are just averaging 262 YPG and 14 PPG. Last week, Bruins (+28) held Penn St to 85 yds on the ground and only lost 27-11. Minnesota (+8") hosted USC. The Gophers punched in a GW touchdown on 4th & goal with :56 then clinched the game with a INT. Minnesota QB Brosmer is hitting 68% on the year and their D is only allowing 114 YPG through the air TY. UCLA has faced the toughest schedule in the country but have covered 3 straight (vs LSU, Oregon & Penn St) so we will give them the edge to stay within the line at home.

OREGON by 1 over Ohio St - Oregon was 0-9 SU vs the Buckeyes until their last meeting in '21. In the Horseshoe, Oregon (+14") put up 612 yards of offense and upset the Buckeyes, 35-28. Oregon is 10-4 SU/ATS when hosting top 10 ranked conference foes. Oregon has the schedule edge (#39 vs #65). Ohio St has the slight edge in offense (#2 vs #7) and on defense (#1 vs #14). Both teams are led by transfer QB's, OSU's Howard is hitting at 71% with a 12-3 ratio while UO's Gabriel is at 78% with 11-3. LW, Ohio St (-18) only led 7-0 at H but scored on 4 straight possessions in the 2H to beat Iowa 35-7. Oregon (-23") led Michigan St 31-7 but Sparty kicked a FG with :25 left to get the backdoor cover. Oregon is now 31-1 at home since 2019 so we will go with them to get the win, as Autzen Stadium will be fired up for their first marquee Big 10 game.

IOWA by 9 over Washington - Teams have not met since 1995. Washington hosted Michigan last week. The Huskies (-1") were trailing 17-14 going into the 4Q but caused a fumble that turned into a TD and an INT that turned into a FG to win 27-17. Iowa (+18) only trailed 7-0 at half but fumbled/intercepted/fumbled in their first 3 2H possessions and fell 35-7 at Ohio St. The Hawkeyes HC Ferentz is 60-40-2 ATS coming off a SU loss and are 25-12-1 ATS as a single digit fav last 11 years. The Hawkeyes have the defensive edge (#8 vs #33) and ST edge (#38 vs #120) but UW has the slight offensive edge (#48 vs #62). Iowa has played a tough schedule (#17 vs #87) and Washington is playing in their 7th straight week and are 5-10 ATS in conference away games and have to travel 1,855 miles so we will go with the Hawkeyes to defend home turf.

Oregon St by 9 over NEVADA - Last met in 2018 here in Reno and Oregon St (+3") lost 37-35 on a last second FG by Nevada. Oregon St is off a 39-31 OT win against Colo St where they led 21-10 4Q but then had to get a last-second FG of their own to send the game to OT where they won it. Nev is off a 35-31 loss to SJSt where they put up 416 yds. OSU is led by their strong 1-2 punch at RB in Hankerson and Griffin, but Griffin (450, 6.2) did leave early last week & is ? here (check status). Nev did face a solid SJSt offense and allowed 441 yds last week incl 327 pass yds and their pass D ranks #75. Oregon St does have the #34 pass D and can contain Nev QB Lewis is hitting 69% (9-5 ratio). Oregon St is off a worse than expected game, but Colo St is a better team than Nev and we feel like we're getting some value here & like OSU to cover the spread.

Penn St by 3 over USC - USC leads the series 6-4. Last meeting was in the '17 Rose Bowl where there was a combined 1,040 yards and Penn St led 49-35 in the 4Q but fell 52-49 (+7). Last week, USC (-8") held a 17-10 lead going in to 4Q but were intercepted twice and punted once, giving up two unanswered touchdowns losing at Minnesota, 24-17. Penn St (-28) hosted UCLA and outgained the Bruins 322-260 in a 27-11 win. Penn St is 9-5 SU but just 5-9 ATS in road conf openers while USC HC Riley is 41-4 at home in his career. USC has the offensive edge (#14 vs #35) but Penn St has the defensive edge (#3 vs #32). USC has faced the #4 schedule (PSU #74) and the Trojans have had two close loses on the road so they won't fold at home.

Memphis by 3 over USF - Since joining the AAC in '13 Memphis has won 6 of 7 but has only covered twice in this conference matchup. Last year both teams combined for 1,163 yards and USF (+13") scored with :55 left to get the backdoor cover losing 59-50. Both teams are coming off byes. Memphis has played the #123 schedule while USF has played the #36. Prior to the bye USF had their first AAC matchup at Tulane. The Bulls got outgained 528-201 and QB Brown went down with an injury, falling 45-10 (+4"). Brown's status is ? for this game. Memphis (-26) held Middle Tennessee to 29 rush yards in a 24-7 win. Memphis is 14-23-2 as a single digit fav L/11 years and HC Silverfield is 6-12 ATS on the road, we like the Bulls to keep it close. Game was scheduled for Friday but due to Hurricane Milton it was moved to Saturday at 3:30.

TUESDAY OCTOBER 15th

Troy vs SOUTH ALABAMA - Battle for the Belt rivalry! Troy has won and covered the past 6 meetings and the "Under" has hit in 6 of the past 7 meetings, with an average of just 38 points scored. SAAla last played 10 days ago at Ark St where they put up 453 yds but only 16 pts as they were SOD once and threw a pick in the RZ. Troy has had a couple extra days off as they played 12 days ago on a Thur vs Texas St where they allowed 467 yds in a 38-17 loss. In this game LY SAAla QB Lopez made his first career start & this ssn is hitting 63% with a 12-1 ratio while Troy's 3 QB's have a combined 9-1 ratio and their top RB Taylor has 399 (5.9).

Kennesaw St vs MIDDLE TENNESSEE - First meeting and first trip to Murfreesboro for KSU. This will also be Kennesaw St's first Tuesday Night game in school history. MT has lost 4 straight and has a game at LA Tech before this takes place. KSU enters fresh off a bye. They are 0-5 and -203 ypg. Prior to their bye they lost at home vs Jax St 63-24 (+16"). The Owls are #134 in the FBS, avg just 227 ypg and they are being held 133 ypg below what their opponents allow on avg. MT has a big edge on offense. We will wait to set a line on this game until after MT plays their game against LA Tech.

Louisiana Tech vs NEW MEXICO ST - Last year was their first CUSA meeting. NIMSt was +2", they led 16-7 at half with a 269-122 yd edge and Aggies won 24-16. Both teams have a game coming up prior to this one. LA Tech is 1-14 SU/4-11 ATS on the road under Sonny Cumbie. NIMSt nearly upset Liberty at home and lost by 10 in their rivalry game vs New Mexico.
