The Green Wave had already clinched a spot in this game going into their Thanksgiving night affair with Memphis. They were -14 but lost 34-24 and were -3 TO's. Army trailed UTSA 17-13 3Q last week. They were ahead 29-17 4Q, allows UTSA to go 75/4 td then missed a fg and int'd UTSA on their last possession. Tulane is +125 ypg against our #70 sked.
