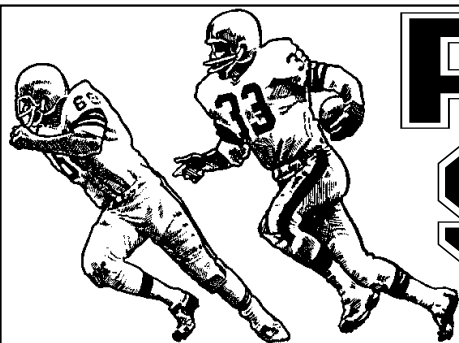

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ OHIO over Louisiana - 3rd mtg. Ohio is 2-0 SU with their last mtg coming in Athens back in '10 when LA was +14' and lost 38-31. The Cajuns are off an easy 77-6 win vs FCS Texas Southern, where LA put up 748 ttl yds incl 440 rush yds. OU is coming off a tough rivalry loss at Marshall (33-31), but QB Rourke had 333 yds of OFF & 4 total td's. OU all'd 305 rush yds LW and now will be tasked w/ trying to stop an LA rush attack putting up 337 rush ypg! On the other hand LA has improved their run DEF (158 ypg) this ssn while OU was one of the top running tms LY (258 rush ypg in '18) and ran for 223 yds LW. The 'Cats are 8-4 the L3Y as a HF. **FORECAST: OHIO by 8**

3★ GEORGIA over Notre Dame - These 2 met in '17 and Georgia held the Irish to 265 yds, getting the go ahead fg with 3:34 left for a 1 pt win. This is UGA's first real test after winning their F/3 by 41 ppg. Notre Dame was tied with Louisville at halftime in their opener and blew out New Mexico 66-14 (-34') a week ago. The Irish only returned 3 of their front 7 and had to replace both interior DLine which will be a concern against UGA's Oline, who we rate as the #2 unit in the country. ND has allowed 231 (5.0) in their F/2 vs lesser opponents. Georgia has topped 260 rush yds in each of their F/3 and avg 287 ypg (7.6) led by D'Andre Swift (292, 9.4). UGA has the experience edge (#36 vs #98). HC Kelly is 0-2 ATS in reg ssn matchups vs the SEC incl a close call at home vs Vandy LY (UGA beat Vandy 41-13). UGA is on a 21-7 ATS run vs FBS foes and we call for that to continue. **FORECAST: GEORGIA by 20**

3★ Nebraska by 17 over ILLINOIS - IL is home for the 3rd time in 4 weeks with a bye on deck, while NU has Ohio St on deck. LY the 'Huskies scored a season high 54 points and won by 19 (-17). NU enters off a 44-8 (-14) win over NIU, their most complete game of the ssn. The win could prove costly however, as DB Taylor-Britt & LT Jaimes left with inj's (CS) and punter Armstrong, who is filling in at K due to inj's, had 2 fg's & a PAT blk'd. The Illini trailed Eastern Michigan 31-17 mid 4Q before tying the game w/1:44 left, but all'd the GW 24 yd fg w/no time left. They were outgd by a MAC program that was travelling for a 3rd straight week! IL is 5-12 as a HD & is on a 10-21 ATS run, while NU is 22-9 ATS away from Lincoln & is on a 8-2 ATS run. The 'Husker offense is getting on track & QB Martinez could have his best game of the ssn this week. **FORECAST: Nebraska by 17**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ PITTSBURGH (+) over Ucf - Pitt is home for the 3rd time in the L/4 weeks and has yet to leave the state of PA, while UCF is travelling outside of FL for the 1st time and has their AAC opener on deck. The Knights have lost 23 of their L/27 road games vs current P5 foes, but beat MD 38-10 (+4) in '17, their last time in that role. LY UCF dominated at home, winning 45-14 (-13) & finishing with a 296 yard edge! The Knights enter off a 45-27 (-9) blowout over Stanford in a game they led 38-7 at HT! True frosh QB Gabriel std'd for the 2nd straight gm over Notre Dame transfer Wimbush and threw for 347 (73%) & 4 td's. The Panthers enter off an emotional 17-10 (+17) loss at rival Penn St, cashing our 3★ LPS on the UNDER (LPS Totals went 3-1 LW, now 8-3, 73% TY!). Pitt had a chance to tie the game with under 5 minutes left from the 1, but opted to attempt a fg & missed. QB Pickett threw for a car high 372 (69%) yds. UCF hasn't ply'd P5 foes in B2B ssn's s/16 and there's a big difference when facing this level of competition consecutively. Pitt is 4-2 as a HD & will keep this game closer than expected. **FORECAST: Ucf by 6**

2★ WASHINGTON ST over UCLA - UCLA has lost their L/3 P12 road openers by 16 ppg, while Wazzu has won 4 straight P12 home openers. This is the Cougars lone home game in a 5 wk stretch & they enter off a 31-24 (-9) win at Houston last friday. After trailing 14-7 at HT, Wazzu went on a 24-3 run in the 2H until allowing a td w/2:21 left. QB Gordon has thrown for 400+ in all 3 games & has a 12-2 ratio. The Bruins enter off a 48-14 (+23) blowout loss vs Oklahoma, where they were outgd 61-31. UCLA has lost 16 of their L/17 games SU and is on a 4-10 ATS run away from the Rose Bowl, while Wazzu is on a 32-17 ATS run & is 10-3 as home chalk hosting P12 foes. We'll call for the Cougars to continue Chip Kelly's struggles with the Bruins. **FORECAST: WASHINGTON ST by 24**

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 19TH

Houston at TULANE - The host has won each of the L/2 meetings. This is TU's 3rd home game the L/4 weeks and they have a bye on deck, while UH is not playing in their home stadium for the 3rd time in 4 weeks. This is the Cougars 4th game & the 3rd time playing on a non-Saturday. UH led Wazzu 14-7 at HT LW, but was outscored 24-3 in the 2H before scoring a td w/2:21 left in their 31-24 (+9) loss. The Cougars allowed 440 (75%) passing. The Green Wave enters off a route over FCS Missouri ST where they were able to rest their starters early. TU is 4-0 as a HD. TU is 12-19 as home chalk. UH is 8-1-1 as an AD. UH is 21-11 ATS away. UH is 14-3-1 as a reg ssn dog. UH is 3-9 as road chalk.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 20TH

Utah at USC - The host has won 6 straight by 9 ppg & this is USC's 3rd home game the L/4 weeks. UT dominated LY's meeting, limiting the Trojans to season lows in yards (205) & FD's (10) while finishing with a 340 yard edge! USC is off an emotional 30-27 (-4) loss in OT at BYU. After tying the gm on a 52 yd fg w/1:43 left, they allowed fg in the extra frame, then QB Slovis had his pass tipped & int'd. With AD Swann stepping down last week, there will be extra pressure on HC Helton. UT enters off a 31-0 shutout over FCS Idaho St, where the starters got plenty of rest in the 2H. The Utes also ply'd at BYU, holding the Cougars to 130 yds less than the Trojans did. USC is 2-4 as a HD. UT is 7-4 as road chalk.

Fiu at LOUISIANA TECH - LT is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in CUSA meetings but the home team is 0-3 ATS. FIU is 3-0 SU/ATS in CUSA road openers but the last loss was also LTH. QB Morgan missed with an injury for the 2nd straight week vs New Hampshire (CS). His replacement, Kaylan Wiggins set a school record with 187 rush yds in the Panthers 30-17 (-13) win. We picked up a 3★ winner, both on these pages and as a LPS, with Louisiana Tech last week. The Bulldogs finished with a 453-290 yd edge and got a pick-6 from All-CUSA CB Amik Robertson in the 35-7 (-11'). QB Smith is completing 69% with a 5-1 ratio and FIU is allowing 59% completions (#91 in our pass eff D ratings). FIU is 6-2 SU on the CUSA road incl 4-0 last year under HC Davis. LT is just 1-7 ATS in CUSA home games and 1-5 as an AF.

Air Force at BOISE ST - Boise leads this series 4-3 and the home team is 5-2 SU. Boise is off an easy win vs FCS Portland ST (45-10) while AF is off a huge upset win at Colorado where the Falcons won the gm in OT 30-23. AF won on the blue turf back in '15 as an 11-pt dog (37-30) but LTH Boise dominated & won 44-19. Boise has held AF's option attack in check the L2Y (191 rush ypg) and this ssn Boise is all'g just 109 rush ypg as they return 7 DEF str's. The AF DEF is strong as well, all'g 243 ypg, but face a Boise OFF that is avg'g 516 ypg. AF is just 2-4-1 ATS in MW road openers, but are facing a Boise team that is just 8-19 ATS as a HF the L5Y. This one of HC Calhoun's best teams at AF & it is tough to trust Boise as a HF which is why we like th Falcons to keep this gm close, especially given their 11-2-1 ATS record the L5Y as an AD.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 21ST

IOWA ST by 13 over Ulm - IST is in an Iowa/Baylor sandwich. The Cyclones have never played a team that was in the SBC at the time of the meeting. ULM enters off a bye following their OT loss at Florida St and has their conference opener on deck. IST is off a physical & emotional 18-17 (+1) loss

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vs rival Iowa that took over 5 hours to complete thanks to 2 lightning delays. It was the closest margin in the 67Y series history. The 'Clones finished with a 418-313 yd edge. ULM is all'g 231 (5.3) rush ypg, but IST is still looking for RB David Montgomery's (#3DC) replacement after RB's Nwangwu, Lang, & Hall comb'd for only 9 carries LW. IST is 1-3 as home chalk.

OHIO ST by 28 over Miami, Oh - Ost is in a B10 sandwich, but is home for the 3rd time in the L/4 weeks, while MU is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks and has their MAC opener on deck. The Buckeyes enter off a 51-10 (-17) blowout at Indy as they've won their F/3 gms by 36 ppg & have held all 3 foes to their ssn low in ttl yds. The Redhawks led rival Cincy 10-0 after 1Q LW before allowing 28 unanswered in their 35-13 (+17) loss. MU was held to 207 yds & lost 3 st'g OL to injury. MU is on an 8-3 ATS run, while OST is on a 6-9 ATS run & is 12-19 as home chalk. The Buckeyes will no doubt roll along by 4 td's.

CLEMSON by 38 over Charlotte - 1st meeting. Charlotte has played 4 Power 5 teams as FBS members, going 0-4 and getting outscored 197-34. Last week we used the 49ers as a 3★ on these pages and picked up an easy winner against hapless UMass, 52-17 (-20'). Charlotte outgained the Minutemen 533-262. Charlotte steps up in competition under 1st year HC Healy while Clemson takes a big step down after big efforts vs A&M and Syracuse. Clemson is at North Carolina next week and HC Swinney will get the reserves a lot of action so their is backdoor potential. We like the way Charlotte has played under their new HC and they are on a 6-1 run as dogs.

INDIANA by 20 over UConn - Indy is in a B10 sandwich, but is home for the 3rd straight week, while UConn enters off a bye with their AAC opener next. This is the Huskies road opener & LY when they travelled to a P5 program they lost at 'Cuse 51-21 (+29). The Hoosiers were without QB Penix (undisclosed inj) in their 51-10 (+17) loss at Ohio St LW, but he could return here (CS). UConn is improved from LY & led IL 13-0 in their last game before all'g 24 unanswered. Indy is 2-5 as chalk vs FBS foes and we'll call for the Huskies to keep their 2nd straight B10 game closer than expected.

Temple by 6 over BUFFALO - TU is in revenge mode after all'g the GW td w/59 left LY & falling 29-36 (-4). The Owls had covered 4 in a row in the series prior. The Owls have lost 13 of their L/18 road openers, but did beat MD in that role LY. This is UB's lone home gm in a 4 wk stretch and they have their MAC opener on deck. New TU HC Carey was 4-0 SU vs the Bulls while at NIU including a win in LY's MAC Champ gm 30-29 (+3). The Owls had a pair of goal-line stands in their 20-17 (+7) outright upset over Maryland LW & finished with a 427-340 yd edge! The Bulls finished with a 26-22 FD edge at Liberty, but trailed 35-10 mid 4Q & lost 35-17 (-5'). While UB is avg 225 (4.5) rush ypg, TU held MD to 3.5 ypc. UB is 9-4 as a HD & is on a 17-8 ATS run. The Bulls will be happy to return home, while the Owls, off their huge upset win with another P5 foe on deck could be looking ahead.

MIAMI, FL by 61 over Central Michigan - First meeting. The 'Canes won easily over FCS Bethune Cookman LW, 66-0 (-40). C Mich got their first FBS win under HC McElwain LW, beating Akron 45-24 (-2). The Chips' held a 533-329 yd edge and led 27-3 2Q. David Moore threw for 316 yds in his debut, playing in place of inj'd QB Dormady (CS). QB Williams has yet to throw an int (6-0 ratio). C Mich had both of their starting CB's from LY leave early (#2 and #6 DC's). They allowed 500 pass yds to normally run-oriented Wisconsin and are giving up 65% completions TY (#111 pass eff D). Moore will find it much tougher in his road start vs the 'Canes D and Miami can put a full effort coming off an FCS foe with a bye on deck. C Mich has two rivalry games on deck.

VIRGINIA by 17 over Old Dominion - First meeting between in-state rivals. Virginia is off a closer than expected 31-24 win over Florida St. The 'Hoos were down 24-17 4Q then had 75/11 pl, 72/5 pl td drives. They stopped FSU on the UVA4 on the final play. QB Perkins completed 75% but threw 2 int's. UVA held a 415-329 yd edge. ODU enters fresh off a bye after playing Virginia Tech closer than expected. Monarchs QB Smartt has yet to throw a td pass and the loss of two 1,000 yd WR's from LY seems to be a big issue (top WR has just 89 yds). UVA has one of the nation's top CB's in Bryce Hall. ODU is 0-7 travelling to P5 foes with avg loss by 31 ppg but UVA is in a HUGE Florida St/Notre Dame sandwich and HC Mendenhall is 0-2 here as 20+ chalk, so we will take the underdog Monarchs to keep it closer than expected.

Coastal Carolina by 21 over UMass - CC is 2-0 SU and ATS against UMass. LTH was LY when UMass actually led 13-10 in 3Q before CC would get 14 unanswered to win 24-13. Coastal is dealing with several inj's to starters, but UMass ret'd just 8 total str's TY and lost to an FCS tm (S.I.LL) at home 2 wks ago by 25 pts. UMass is giving up 528 ypg and 48 ppg this ssn, and CC is off a big win vs Kansas 2 wks ago & gained 521 yds LW. CC's DEF on the other hand has been improved this ssn, all'g just 237 ypg but opposing QB's are hitting 72%. CC is off a 46-7 win vs an FCS foe while UMass got throttled by Charlotte 52-17 (262-533). CC is on a 3-7-1 ATS run, but one of those wins was 2 wks ago at Kansas and UMass is on a 3-8 ATS slide as a HD. We'll back CC here by 3 TD's as UMass has shown us no reason to back them at all this ssn.

Michigan St by 10 over NORTHWESTERN - The visitor has won 10 of the L/12 meetings and MST is in revenge mode after failing to hold onto a 2H lead on homecoming in LY's 29-19 (-10') loss. This is Sparty's road opener, while NW has been home 3 straight weeks. The 'Cats were fresh off a bye LW, but only led 16-14 at HT in their 30-14 (-18) win over UNLV (Button 9 Thursday comp winner!). QB Johnson has completed less than 50% in both games and st'g RB Bowser DNP (inj, CS) while bkp RB Brown was inj'd. MST enters off an emotional 10-7 (-14') loss vs AZSt. It appeared Sparty had tied the gm to send it into OT, however, they were penalized for 12 men on the field and the re-kick from 47 yds never had a chance. MST finished w/404-216 yd & 23-14 FD edges & has held all 3 foes to their ssn low in ttl yds. We'll call for Sparty to get their revenge by DD's.

Troy by 21 over AKRON - 2nd mtg, first here. Only matchup was back in '17 when UA was +16' at Troy, and the Trojans got a 4Q TD w/ 1:06 left to avoid the upset (22-17). Troy lost an OFF slugfest to S.Miss 47-42 (528-626) while UA travelled to C.Mich and lost 45-24 while all'g 533 yds. Coming into the ssn Troy rated the edge on all 3 phases and were the more exp'd team. UA is avg'g just 305 ypg & 48 rush ypg this ssn, while Troy's OFF is putting up 528 ypg incl 393 pass ypg. Last week the Zips (#125 pass DEF) all'd 344 pass yds & face Troy QB Barker who threw for 504 yds & 4 td vs a better DEF UA is just 8-23 ATS as a HD the L/11 years while Troy is 5-2 ATS as a AF dating back to '17. All these factors have us favoring the road team here by double digits.

Boston College by 14 over RUTGERS - Former Big East rivals haven't played s/'04. RU enters off a bye with a trip to Michigan on deck, while this is BC's road opener and they host WF next. RU QB Carter suffered a concussion in their last game & the Knights were held under 50 pass yds for EIGHTH time in 38 games under HC Ash! The Eagles enter off an embarrassing 48-24 (-20') home loss to a Kansas team that hadn't beaten a P5 foe on the road s/'08! While BC has put up ssn highs in ttl yds allowed by each of their F/3 foes, they've also all'd 2 of those 3 foes to finish with ssn highs in ttl yds & is all'g 214 (4.9) rush ypg & 68% completions. BC is on a 16-6 ATS run in the reg ssn & is 7-2 as DD chalk vs FBS foes. The Eagles will feast on the Knights as they want to get LW's result out of their minds as quickly as possible.

SYRACUSE by 6 over Western Michigan - LY's meeting was a high scoring affair with Syracuse coming out on top 55-42 (-5) in the opener. This time Cuse is off B2B physical beatdowns by Maryland and Clemson where the Orange defense allowed a combined 1,272 yards and 103 pts. W Michigan absolutely destroyed Georgia St 57-10 (-8). The Broncos finished with +358 yd & +12 FD edges. HC Babers has 2 losses to Group-of-5 foes but is 2-0 SU/ATS vs MAC foes. The Broncos rushed for 450 (10.2) LW and Cuse has been gashed for 288 ypg (7.8) the L/2. W Mich has 4 starters back from LY's Dline but have allowed 231 rush ypg (6.2) but they did get 4 sks LW and Cuse' Oline has been their biggest issue, allowing 12 sks in the L/2 and avg just 92 (2.4). Cuse only has Holy Cross on deck but we think W Mich will give the Orange their best shot here.

NC STATE by 15 over Ball St - NCSt's defense struggled mightily last week against West Virginia, after allowing 375 tll yds in their F/2, they allowed 445 vs WV. QB McKay hit just 23-48-207-1-0 in the 44-27 (-7) loss. Ball St had 4 TO's that turned into 21 FAU points LW in their 10 pt loss. The Cardinals secondary was picked apart for 366 yds. Ball St has a significant experience edge (#13 vs #121). QB Pitt has hit 72% with an 8/2 ratio. Ball St is 2-9 ATS on the road, though both covers came vs P5 foes in their L/2 road openers and 6-15 as a dog. Ball St has a significant situational edge with their bye on deck and NCSt in a WV/Florida St sandwich but the poor tech angles mean we can only give a slight edge.

Toledo by 1 over COLORADO ST - Series tied 1-1, but last mtg was here back in 1973 (CSt won 21-14). CSt is off their 2nd Power-5 loss this ssn (lost at Ark 55-34) while UT had a bye 2 wks ago and just faced an FCS foe last wk (45-0 win). UT is an impressive 6-2 ATS as an AF dating back to '17 and the Rockets will also have their starting QB Guadagni for this one (266 yds, 3 td last week). CSt has no problem on OFF this ssn as they are avg'g 505 ypg and QB Hill is hitting 67% for 837 yds & an 8-2 ratio, but suffered a knee inj LW and could miss this gm. CSt's main concern is DEF, as they are all'g 498 ypg & 54 ppg vs FBS foes. CSt is just 6-11 ATS vs non-conf foes the L4Y. UT has the better defense and is the more exp'd team, and we'll call for a narrow Rockets win in Fort Collins.

NEW MEXICO by 6 over New Mexico St - 110th Rio Grande Rivalry game. NM is 13-6 SU (9-9-1 ATS) dating back to 2000. NM is off a brutal 66-14 loss at Notre Dame where they were w/o their HC, while NMSt fell at home vs SDSU 31-10 and are 0-3 for the 3rd time in the L4Y. Both tms DEF's are near the bottom of the FBS rankings as NM allows 575 ypg & NMSt allows 539 ypg. On paper NMSt has the better OFF, but has not showed much vs superior foes (303 ypg, 9 ppg) while NM still is not fully settled on 1 QB to run the offense, but did rush for 212 yds LW at ND. The visitor is 8-2-1 ATS the last 11, and NM is 0-8 ATS as a HF while NMSt is 12-22 ATS as an AD under HC Martin. While we do like the home team to win outright, we expect this game to be close as 4 of the L/5 gms have been decided by 9 pts or less.

Washington by 6 over BYU - HTJ is 7-2 SU all-time in series. LY Washington won 35-7 as a 17' pt HF ending a streak of 3 str reg ssn losses to BYU. UW had a 26-7 FD and 464-194 yd edge as BYU trailed 21-0 at HT & 35-0 into 4Q before scoring a td w/:41 left thanks to a muffed punt. However UW is just 1-3 here all-time & LTH ('10) the Huskies led 17-13 HT, but lost 23-17 (394-408). LW the Huskies were off a 1 pt loss to Cal & took their frustrations out on Hawaii, winning 52-20 as a 21' pt HF. LW BYU which is the only team to open with four P5 teams TY, was coming off a 29-26 road upset of Tennessee and beat #24 USC 30-27 in OT. That USC team was led by a truw frosh QB making his first road start. Washington is led by former Georgia starting QB Eason, who in his first 3 sts at Wash is avg 258 ypg with a 7-1 ratio. We look for the Huskies to pull out the close win here.

ARIZONA ST by 8 over Colorado - CU has lost 1 of their L/16 true road openers. AZSt had won 8 of 9 meetings, but travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks LY, lost 28-21 (+2'). The host in the series is 8-1 ATS. The Sun Devils enter off an emotional come-from-behind win at Michigan St. AZSt scored the GW td w/:50 left and benefitted from a MST penalty that resulted in having to re-kick which resulted in a miss. The Sun Devils were outgd 404-216 & outFD'd 23-14. A week after their emotional win over Nebraska, we went against the Buff's & used a 4★ LPS (PERFECT 6-0 day on sides!!) in their 30-23 (-3') OT loss. CU trailed 23-10 mid 4Q & was outgd 444-325. AZSt is 8-4 as home chalk.

OLE MISS by 3 over California - Cal won the first meeting in '17, getting a 30 yd IR td with 3 min left to seal the 27-16 upset (+3). Ole Miss was more than 4 td chalk LW vs FCS SE Louisiana but only led 34-29 until kicking 2 4Q figs. Cal led N Texas 20-0 1Q last week then got just a fg over the last 3Q and only won 23-17 as DD chalk. We picked up a 4★ winner on the Under 50' (Totals 3-1 LW, now 8-3 on the year!!!). Cal only finished with 278 yds and QB Garbers hit just 41% against the Mean Green's rebuilt secondary. Cal is 4-0 as an AD, having pulled 3 outright upsets since LY. We look for a low scoring affair (Cal Under 12 out of L/14, Ole Miss under 5 straight vs FBS foes) and we will call for the Rebels to win by a field goal.

FLORIDA by 10 over Tennessee - Tennessee has won just 1 of the L/14 mtgs and haven't won in 'The Swamp' since 2003 (2-5 ATS). LY Florida won 47-21 (-3') but yards were nearly even and the

Volts were -5 TO's. After dropping their F/2 games in shocking manner (first time 0-2 since 1988), Vols got an easy win over an FCS foe. Florida got revenge against Kentucky last week, but it came at a cost as QB Franks is OFY (Leg). Bkp QB Kyle Trask hit 9-13-126 and the Gators won 29-21 (-8') after trailing 21-10 4Q. Tenn's D was missing LY's leading tkr LB Daniel Bituli the first 2 games and they could get their top CB Bryce Thompson back from susp as well (CSU). QB Guarantano has a 19-5 ratio the last 2 years and we expect him to take advantage of a beat up Florida secondary who allowed 267 pass yds LW to KY's backup QB. Could we go with the underdog Vols, who are 3-1ATS in this series when they are a DD dog in this series as our 5★ GOM?

Georgia St by 6 over TEXAS ST - The visitor is 4-1 SU in the series (3-2 ATS). GSt is playing their 3rd road gm this ssn & are off a 57-10 drubbing at WMich, while TXSt dropped to 0-3 after a blowout 47-17 road loss to SMU. LY TXSt jumped out to a 33-10 lead after 3Q and held on to pull the road upset (+6') 40-31, which means GSt will be out for revenge. GSt is a run-first team & are avg'g 209 ypg rushing while TXSt has all'd 275 rush ypg this ssn. TXSt is putting up just 301 ypg (25 rush ypg) but could get their OFF going vs a GSt DEF all'g 543 ypg & 43 ppg. GSt is 5-1 ATS in their SBC road openers, while TXSt is just 2-4 ATS in SBC home openers. Both of these teams are exp'd, but GSt has the coaching edge and we like the Panthers to pick up the win.

ALABAMA by 34 over Southern Miss - SEC sandwich spot here for Bama, coming off a 47-23 (-25) win at South Carolina. Nick Saban will likely go out of his way to get the run game going after being held to 3.3 ypc in 2 Power-5 matchups. SM outlasted Troy in a 47-42 road win (+3). The Golden Eagles allowed 504 pass yds vs Troy, which is surprising considering they brought back 3 starters from a secondary that finished #22 in our PDR last year. Despite the poor results last week SM's defense is capable of getting a couple stops needed for the Golden Eagles to stay within the line. SM is on a 6-0-1 ATS run and 10-3 run as dogs while Bama is on a 1-5 ATS run.

MISS ST by 14 over Kentucky - The home team is 4-0 SU/ATS. The Bulldogs had won 7 straight from '09-'15. KY has won 2 of the L/3. LY the game was tied 7-7 at half, the 'Cats outstrapped the Bulldogs 229-56 and won 28-7 (+9'). Sawyer Smith had his first SEC start LW in 'The Swamp' and nearly led the upset. KY led 21-10 (+8') 4Q and missed a 35 yd fg then UF got a 76 yd td run while running the clock out. HC Moorhead benched QB Stevens in the 2H after 2 int's in the Bulldogs 7 pt loss vs Kansas St (-7). Miss St finished with +83 yd & +4 FD edges. Both QB's struggled with TO's last week. Miss St RB Hill leads the SEC with 431 (6.6). We will call for a bounceback effort and a 2 td win for the Bulldogs who are 6-2 as a HF.

Lsu by 27 over VANDERBILT - These 2 last met in 2010, LSU has won the last 7 meetings by 17 ppg and Vandy has been held to just 5 ppg in the L/6. We were big believers in Joe Burrow before the season started and he hasn't disappointed, completing 83% with an 11-2 ratio! Vandy enters fresh off a bye while LSU was able to rest 7 starters vs an FCS foe and still won 65-14. Burrow could have yet another big game against Vandy's pass D that allowed 509 vs Purdue 2 weeks ago. RB Vaughn hasn't found much room to run in the F/2 behind a rebuilt Oline, avg just 4.1 ypc. LSU has a huge experience edge (#19 vs #107) along with edges on OFF, DEF and ST's. Vandy is 1-6 as a HD and HC Orgeron is 8-3 in SEC road games.

NORTH CAROLINA by 7 over Appalachian St - These schools are 163 miles apart but meet for the first time since 1940. This will be the first time in Mack Brown's 2nd stint that the Heels will be favored after pulling 2 outright upsets with 4th quarter comebacks and nearly doing the same last 3Q. The Tar Heels are proving to be notorious slow starters, getting outscored 60-32 in the 1st 3Q then outscoring foes 38-9 in the 4Q. App St enters fresh off a bye. The Mountaineers have the experience edge (#9 vs #103) and normally you'd expect a Power-5 team to overlook the Group of 5 foe, but NC is off B2B losing seasons and a bowl is a real possibility. The strength of NC's offense is their run game and App St allowed 230 (5.8) rushing vs Charlotte. HC Brown will have them ready to play early this time and the Tar Heels are 25-16 as a fav so we give them a slight lean.

TEXAS A&M by 14 over Auburn - The home team is 0-6-1 ATS in this series. A&M was in control LY, leading 24-14 more than halfway through the 4Q but QB Mond threw an int to give the Tigers new life and they scored 2 late td's. A&M finished with a 421-278 yd edge. Both teams come in fresh after lopsided wins over FCS foes. This is QB Nix first career 'true' road start and first SEC start. Nix is only completing 52% (4-2). A&M counters with a defense holding foes 186 ypg below their avg and they got their top CB Debone Renfro back from suspension LW. The Tigers rush for 282 (2.6) ypg while A&M is holding foes to 84 (3.3) and kept Clemson's potent run game to just 121 (3.7). QB Mond is hitting 65% and true frosh RB Isaiah Spiller avg 8.8 ypc. Auburn was fortunate to escape against Oregon. They won't have such luck against a hungry A&M team out for revenge. A&M is 6-1 as a HF under HC Fisher and Auburn is 0-4 as an AD. With the 12th man on our side, we could go with A&M as our Sept 5★.

Michigan by 3 over WISCONSIN - UM hasn't lost their road opener in B2B seasons s/2014-'15. Both enter off a bye. LY was a meeting of Top 15 foes and UW was held to a ssn low 11 FD's in the 25 point loss, which was the most lopsided under HC Chryst and also snapped the Badgers 17 game regular ssn B10 winning streak. The 'Wolves' have been slow to adapt to the changes brought in by new OC Gattis and UW is the only FBS program that has yet to allow a point. RB Taylor remains one of if not the best RB in the nation, but UM is all g just 3.0 ypc. UW is 6-14 ATS in their first 3 home games. The 'Wolves' have failed to live up to their lofty pre-ssn hype, however, we feel this is the game they start putting it all together. The 'Wolves' defense matches up well with the UW power run game and we will call for the outright upset, making this our Underdog Play of the Week! **FORECAST: Michigan by 3**

TULSA by 8 over Wyoming - The home team has won 4 straight in the series with the last meeting in '98. WV won a non-conf road game under HC Bohl for just the 2nd time in 10 games 2 wks ago at TXSt. The Pokes have their MW opener on deck, while TU has a bye on tap. The Hurricane trailed rival OKSt 17-0 early, but led 21-20 at HT before being held scoreless in the 2H. While they all'd 506 yds, that was the fewest OKSt has gained. WV enters 3-0 SU for the 1st time s/11, but has trailed by DD's in all 3. They were held to only 287 yds LW in their win over FCS Idaho. The Pokes were held to just 293 yds in their lone road trip at TXSt & the Hurricane have held all 3 of their foes to ssn lows in yds. We'll call for TU to win by over a td.

MISSOURI by 3 over South Carolina - SC is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series and have pulled B2B outright upsets. LY in a driving rain storm, the Gamecocks got a 33 yd GW fg and won 37-35 (+2). HC Muschamp showed he wasn't afraid to trust true frosh QB Hilinski in his first start LW vs Bama. Hilinski fared well at times, throwing for 324 yds and had 57 attempts. SC was only outgained 571-459. Missouri is fresh off a blowout win over an FCS foe. The key matchup will be MO's Oline, with 3 all-SEC caliber guys against SC's Dline who just held Bama to 76 (3.0) rush and is allowing 129 (3.8). QB Bryant will try to take advantage of SC's pass D, which ranks #113 in our efficiency ratings. HC Muschamp prefers the dog role (11-3 L3Y) and is 3-0 SU/ATS in their first SEC road gm.

West Virginia by 3 over KANSAS - KU has lost 7 of the 8 meetings including 5 straight and has also lost 9 B12 openers in a row. WV has a bye on deck. The last time these 2 HC's were on opposite sidelines was in '14 when Miles was the HC at LSU & Brown was the OC at KY and the Tigers easily handled the 'Cats by 38 pts (-10'). The Jayhawks enter with an extra day of prep/rest following their 48-24 (+20') upset at BC last Friday, which snapped their 48 gm road losing streak vs P5 foes. After being held to just 280 yds at home vs Coastal Carolina, the Jayhawks exploded for 567 LW including 329 (7.3) rush as RB's Herbert & Williams each had 100+. WV entered LW's gm vs NCSt avg an FBS worst 1.1 ypc & had scored a total of 27 pts, but finished with 173 (6.2) rush in their 44-27 (+7) win.

TEXAS by 7 over Oklahoma St - TX has lost 7 of the L/9 meetings and is in revenge mode after entering LY ranked #6 before losing 38-35 (-3). OKSt is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks, while the 'Horns have yet to leave the state of Texas and has a bye on deck. TX led Rice 31-0 at the half & was able to rest their starters most of the 2H in their 48-13 (-32') rout. The Pokes led in-state rival Tulsa 17-0 early, but trailed 21-20 at the half before outscoring their foes 20-0 in the 2H. OKSt has finished with the most yds allowed by each of their FBS foes & is avg 285 (6.0) rush ypg, but the 'Horns are all g 87 (3.0) rush ypg.

KENT ST by 11 over Bowling Green - Opening conf game for both. Winner receives the Anniversary Award. BG leads all-time series 60-20-6 & have won 3 straight in Kent. LTH BG led 17-0 into 2Q & 20-9 at HT & that was the closest KS got, as BG pulled away for a 44-16 win. Last year the game was tied at 28 before KSU scored the GW td w 1:50 left. Both teams come in 1-2 SU & ATS. Both were competitive mid-2Q LW as BG only trailed LT 14-7 & KSU only trailed #8 Auburn 14-10. That comparison also shows the difference as the Flashes have face the much tougher schedule (#20-#109). Even looking over their FCS foes shows the difference. BG beat Morgan ST 46-3, while KSU just got by Kennesaw ST 26-23 but MSU os 0-2 being outscored by 47 ppg while Kennesaw ST is 2-1 & ranked in the top 10 of the FCS. We look for the Flashes to show the difference this week.

TCU by 14 over Smu - This is the 99th meeting in the Battle for the Iron Skillet. SMU has lost 7 straight, their longest losing streak in the series, but has covered 9 of the L/15. LY the Ponies were held to a ssn low 242 yds in the 42-12 (+22') loss. SMU hasn't beaten a ranked foe s/86. Both schools have their conf openers on deck. The Ponies are 3-0 SU for the 1st time s/84 after their 47-17 (-17') win vs TXSt! SMU finished with a 639-241 yd edge. TCU is still looking for stability at QB, but RB Anderson led a ground attack that finished with 346 (6.0) rush at Purdue LW. The Frogs all'd just 204 yds as we cashed our 3★ LPS on the UNDER (LPS Totals finished 3-1, part of a 9-1 Saturday on Star rated LPS plays!). SMU is 4-8 ATS away from Dallas. The Ponies are improved, but now taking on a premier defense, won't have the same kind of results.

ARKANSAS by 20 over San Jose St - First meeting. We went with Arkansas as a 2H on these pages, then upgraded to a 3H LPS last week vs Colorado St. The Hogs came through with yet another winner, 55-34 (-10). QB Starkel threw for 305 yds and 3 td's. San Jose St enters fresh off a bye. The Spartans lost to Tulsa prior to their bye, 34-16 (+6'). SJSt is 1-4 ATS in road openers. Arkansas has given up B2B 300-yd passers and the Spartans have an experienced QB in Josh Love so there is backdoor potential. The Hogs also have A&M on deck and SJSt was 4-1 as a 20+ dog last year. Arkansas wins easily but San Jose St keeps it closer than expected.

UAB by 8 over South Alabama - First mtg. UAB is off a bye while SAAla dropped to 1-2 after a 42-6 home loss to Memphis. SAAla's DEF had shown improvement this ssn, all g just 271 ypg and 25 ppg in the F/2 gms. Last week though they all'd 530 yds & 42 pts vs Mem. UAB is an impressive 10-2-1 ATS s/ returning in '17, but barely beat an FCS team at home in Week 1 and SAAla HC Campbell is 4-3 ATS vs non-conf foes. SAAla has been able to run the ball this ssn (199 rush ypg) but faces a UAB run D all g just 90 rush ypg. This is a battle of 2 very inexp'd teams (SAAla #125, UAB #127), but SAAla is just 4-9 SU in non-conf gms the L3Y and it is hard to ignore UAB's strong home ATS record.

Oregon by 7 over STANFORD - Stanford has won 5 of the L/7 meetings and this is their lone home game in a 4 wk stretch, while UO is playing their 1st true road game, but does have a bye on deck. LY the Cardinal trailed 24-7 at the half, rallied to force OT on the final play of regulation, and won 38-31 (-2'). QB Costello returned for Stanford LW at UCF, but the Cardinal trailed 21-0 mid 1Q & 38-7 at the half in their 45-27 (+9) blowout loss. Stanford has all'd 2 first yr st'g QB's to complete 85% & 73% the L2W & is now facing 1 of the nations best in Justin Herbert. Speaking of Herbert, he's coming off a 5 td performance in the Ducks 35-3 blowout over FCS Montana. UO is 10-18 ATS vs P12 foes & is on a 12-27 ATS run, while Stanford is on a 35-23 ATS run & is 7-3 ATS on the Farm.

Baylor by 21 over RICE - BU has won 9 straight in the series & enters fresh off a bye, but does have their B12 opener on deck. Rice is playing a 3rd straight P5 foe, all in Houston, and has their CUSA opener on deck. The Bears have began the ssn outscoring their F/2 foes 119-31 and is +261 ypg. Rice trailed Texas 38-0 LW before scoring 2 td's in the L/7:50 of regulation. All 3 of the Owls foes this year have all'd their fewest tl yds against them, as Rice is avg just 277 ypg. BU is 2-5 ATS in reg ssn non-conf games. BU is 6-12 as road chalk & is 1-4 ATS off a bye, while Rice is on a 6-3 ATS run. The Bears are clearly superior, but after an easy week with their conference opener next, could be due for a flat spot and we'll call for the Owls to keep it closer than expected.

NORTH TEXAS by 12 over Utsa - Home team is 4-1 SU/5-0 ATS. The L/2 matchups were both decided by a fg with NT winning both. The Mean Green trailed Cal 20-0 1Q LW but got within 5 pts in the end, holding the Golden Bears to just a fg over the L3Q. We went against UTSA LW and picked up a 3★ winner in their 31-13 (+17) loss vs Army. The Roadrunners offense has picked up where it left off LY. They've been held under 300 yds in 15 of their L/19 games, but one of those came against this same North Texas team LY in the finale. N Texas is 1-6 as CUSA chalk and are on a 2-10 ATS run.

FLORIDA ST by 11 over Louisville - Louisville nearly made it 3 straight outright upsets LY when they led 24-21 with a chance to run the clock out when QB Pass threw an int and FSU responded with a 58 yd td. We cashed a 3★ LPS on Louisville last week in their 38-21 win over WKU (-10). L'ville outrushed WKU 210-42 and WR Atwell had 141 yds and 3 td's. The Cardinals played w/o QB Pass (foot) and bkp Malik Cunningham left in the 3Q (head), so check status on both. Once again FSU entered the 4Q with a lead. Once again FSU blew the lead, allowing Virginia to score 3 td's and the 'Noles were stopped on the final play from the UVA 4. FSU has been outscored 52-21 in the 4Q. L'ville is rushing for 260 (5.7) but FSU only allows 171 (3.9). HC Satterfield is on a 15-3-2 ATS run but this is their road opener and FSU has significant edges at QB and on defense. The 'Noles will get right this week with a double-digit win.

Nevada by 14 over UTEP - 4th mtg. Tms met from '00-'02 w/Nev holding a 2-1 edge. LTH ('01) Nev (-5) trailed 17-14 at HT, but came back to win 48-31. UTEP is off a bye, while Nev just barely beat FCS Weber ST 19-13. UTEP was held to just 3 pts & 131 yds vs Tex Tech 2 weeks ago while Nev is looking to start a ssn 3-1 for the first time s/14. The 'Pack have the stronger OFF, but their DEF is all g 571 total ypg & 413 pass ypg vs FBS foes, but did face an angry Oregon tm off a tough loss 2 wks ago. UTEP is 3-10 ATS as a HD the L4Y and the Miners have just 1 SU win over an FBS team since 2017. Nev is just 1-4 ATS the L5Y as an AF & are just 3-8 SU in non-conf gms in that same span. Given UTEP's poor record vs FBS foes, we'll side with the 'Pack by 2 TDs.

Utah St by 3 over SAN DIEGO ST - Dating back to 1968 SDSSt has won 10 straight over Utah St by an avg of nearly 21 ppg. These tms have only met twice as MW foes and SDSSt is 2-0 SU/ATS, winning 48-14 in '15 & 40-13 in '16. The Aztecs are off a win at NMSSt 31-10 while Utah St is coming off a bye. USU's QB Jordan Love is off to a solid start, hitting 71% for 710 yds & a 4-3 ratio & in USU's F/2 gms they are avg'g 657 ypg, but will face a solid SDSSt DEF that is all g just 248 ypg & 8 ppg. The Aztecs come into this gm as a HF, and HC Rocky Long is 5-0-1 ATS as a HD the L7Y. USU is 4-2 ATS in MW road openers and in HC's Andersen's previous stint here ('09-'12) he was just 3-6 as a AF. USU has an exp'd DEF back & SDSSt's OFF is still a work in progress (336 ypg & 20 ppg) & we'll back the Aggies to leave San Diego with a close win.

4★ INDIANAPOLIS over Atlanta - The Colts are home for the 1st time in '19 following a 2 pt DIV road win against the Titans (QB Brissett 3 TD passes). The Falcons meanwhile rebounded from a disastrous season opener at MIN to take care of business against the Eagles behind a late TD pass. Although both squads seem to be fairly even on paper coming in, we're going trend heavy here as not only have the Colts gone a solid 11-5 ATS in their matchups against the NFC, but the Falcons have been the polar opposite with 10 consec ATS losses outside of their conference with a 11 pt avg spread defeat. **FORECAST: INDIANAPOLIS by 10**

3★ ARIZONA over Carolina - After dropping each of their first 2 HG's of the ssn incl a 20-14 defeat last Thur against TB where they finished with a 343-289 yd edge, the Panthers head to the desert to take on a Cardinals squad that suffered a 6 pt loss LW in BAL (QB Murray 349 pass yds). In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Panthers jumped out to a 24-0 lead in the 2Q of their eventual 30-20 home victory. While CAR will be the favorite once again this time around, their 2-8 overall ATS run coming in and 1-7-1 spread mark as an AF has us calling for the Cardinals to earn their first win of the '19 campaign. **FORECAST: ARIZONA by 4**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Detroit (+) over PHILADELPHIA - Following a 3 pt home upset of the Chargers to move to 1-0-1 on the ssn, the Lions head to PHI following an '18 campaign in which they went a perfect 3-0 ATS as a NDIV AD. While the Eagles dropped a 4 pt matchup on the road LW to ATL, they also lost a good portion of their receiving unit in the process with injury (CS for WK 3). In their most recent meeting ('16), the Lions (+3) connected on a GW 29-yd FG w/1:28 left for the 24-23 victory (PHI 346-244 yd edge). With the Eagles struggling early on in their first home matchup (trailed WAS 17-0 in 2Q during WK 1) and having a short week on deck as they travel to Lambeau, we'll go ahead and cut our lean off at a FG in this one as they've gone just 2-7 ATS as a HF. **FORECAST: PHILADELPHIA by 3**

OTHER PLAYS

Tennessee at JACKSONVILLE - Thursday - The Titans moved to 1-1 on the ssn following a 2 pt home loss to the Colts. The Jags meanwhile went for the win late vs HOU (2 pt NG after TD w/30 left) in the eventual 13-12 defeat (JAX 281-263 yd edge). In their 2 meetings a ssn ago, the Titans held JAX to just 15 combined pts in the 2-game sweep (RB Henry 238 rush yds & 4 TD's in Wk 14 matchup in Nashville). While the Jaguars have cashed just 2 of their past 8 DIV meetings overall against the spread, keep in mind that they've covered 3 of their past 4 as a HD coming in. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday. GREEN BAY by 10 over Denver** - Memorable matchup for the Broncos faithful who won their very first championship (SBXXXIII, '97 ssn) against the Packers. Following a 2 pt home loss LW against the Bears (1st 0-2 start in 20 yrs!) where CHI hit a 53-yd FG as time expired (3★ LP Winner on Under 40), the Broncos head to Lambeau where they have never won (0-5-1 SU, 34-15 avg score!). The Packers picked up a 3★ Newsletter Winner LW at home against the Vikings thanks to an opportunistic defense that forced 4 TO's. While GB does have a short turnaround with a Thur night home matchup against the Eagles, the Broncos are just 4-12 ATS as an AD coming in which never bodes well.

KANSAS CITY by 7 over Baltimore - This marks the only HG in the month of Sept for the Chiefs who return to Arrowhead following a pair of convincing wins against the Jaguars and Raiders (Mahomes 443 yds & 4 TD vs OAK). The Ravens meanwhile took advantage of playing an extremely light early season schedule with a 49 pt win in MIA and a 6 pt victory LW at home against the Cardinals where QB Jackson 392 tl yds & 2 TD's. In their Wk 14 matchup of a year ago inside of Arrowhead, the Chiefs (-6) needed a TD pass w/53 left to force OT where they eventually won it there (27-24, KC 441-321 yd edge). With neither squad being challenged so far in the young season, we're going to put our projection right at the opening line.

BUFFALO by 10 over Cincinnati - After a disastrous 24 pt home loss a wk ago against the 49ers where they had a 572-316 yd disadvantage, CIN is back on the road for the 2nd time in 3 wks to take on a Bills squad that they've had quite a bit of recent success against (4-1 overall run incl 2-0 at BUF). The Bills are home for the first time in '19 following a 2-game sweep at MetLife Stadium against the Jets and Giants. While CIN does come into action with an excellent 8-2 ATS mark as an AD, we're giving BUF a small lean here as not only have they covered 8 of their past 12 home openers, but they're also 10-5-1 ATS when listed as chalk inside of New Era Field.

MINNESOTA by 10 over Oakland - Rematch of Super Bowl XI ('76), a meeting that saw the Raiders claim an easy 32-14 victory. After a pair of DIV road matchups to begin the year including an 18 pt loss a week ago to the Chiefs where KC had a 467-307 yd edge, the Raiders (6-0 ATS in road openers) now journey away from the "Black Hole" for quite some time as their next HG isn't until the first Sunday of Nov! The Vikings return home at 1-1 on the year following a 5 pt loss to the Packers in Lambeau (3★ Newsletter Winner on GB!). With MIN on a 20-5-1 ATS run as a HF and covering 15 of their past 20 against the AFC, we'll side with them here as OAK has gone a porous 3-11-2 ATS in non-conf meetings.

NEW ENGLAND by 20 over NY Jets - Although the Jets have gone a solid 4-1-1 ATS in road openers, they head to Foxboro on short rest following a MNF matchup against the Browns. The Patriots on the other hand return home following a 2-0 start where they've outscored the Steelers and Dolphins by a 76-3 combined margin (27-11 FD & 381-184 yd edges vs MIA). In their head to head contests over the L3Y, the Patriots are a perfect 6-0 SU (4-2 ATS) with a 20 pt avg MOV. While the Jets do have an early bye on deck, backing them here without QB Darnold would be dangerous as they've actually struggled in that role over the past 3 ssn's with a trio of ATS losses (14 pt avg spread defeat).

DALLAS by 24 over Miami - It's been a rough start to the season for Dolphins' fans following a 2nd consec home blowout against the Patriots (MIA outscored 102-10 & outgained by 320 ypg TY). The Cowboys on the other hand have picked up a pair of victories inside of their DIV incl LW's 10 pt win in D.C. against the Redskins where QB Prescott had another big game with 269 pass yds & 3 TD's. While the Dolphins have covered 4 consec road openers, backing them at any point this ssn (despite the inflated lines) is risky, especially when the Cowboys are on an 8-1-1 ATS run heading in.

TAMPA BAY by 3 over NY Giants - Following a 6 pt upset in Charlotte against the Panthers last Thur where they held RB McCaffrey to just 53 tl yds, the Bucs return home with a few days of extra rest. The Giants meanwhile are back on the road for the 2nd time in '19 following a 2 TD loss to the Bills. While the Bucs were done in by 4 int's in LY's 38-35 defeat to the Giants in NY, they did have 31-19 FD & 510-359 yd edges. While this is TB's only matchup at home in a 48 day period (next HG on 11/10!), keep in mind that the Giants are 8-1 ATS as a NDIV AD.

SEATTLE by 7 over New Orleans - The schedule remains tough early on for the Saints who are back on the West Coast for a 2nd consec week following an 18 pt loss to the Rams where they lost QB Brees to a thumb inj in the 1H. The Seahawks meanwhile return home after an upset win in PIT against a banged-up Steelers squad (SEA 25-16 FD & 426-261 yd edges). In their 2 most recent trips to the Pacific NW, the Saints have seen the Seahawks come away with a pair of victories incl the memorable 41-36 (+10) WC Rnd contest that featured the "Beast Quake." While Marshawn Lynch has since retired, this SEA team is still very capable of taking down one of the favorites in the NFC, especially if their future HOF signal-caller is missing (Saints have failed to cover 6 of their past 7 overall ATS).

LA CHARGERS by 1 over Houston - Following a 3 pt road loss against DET where they had a 424-339 yd edge, the Chargers return home to take on a Texans squad that narrowly earned their 1st victory of the ssn LW against the Jaguars (JAX went for 2 w/30 remaining trailing by 1). In their most recent matchup in '16, the Texans were forced into 4 TO's in the 21-13 defeat (HOU 353-302 yd edge). In fact, since the Texans' arrival to the NFL in the '02 season, the Chargers have covered each of the 6 matchups (5-1 SU) with an avg spread win of 7 ppg. Despite the favorable history for the Chargers, we like HOU to stay within the line here as not only have the Chargers gone just 3-9 ATS as a NDIV HF, but the Texans are on an 8-3-1 ATS run overall.
