4★ NOTRE DAME over Georgia Tech- ND has won 3 of the last 4 mtgs including LY when the Irish were -20' and led 31-7 but gave up a 4Q td for a backdoor cover. ND had a 240-66 yd edge in the 1H. Last week we used Notre Dame as our 5★ College GOY (-6') and the Irish dominated, taking a 28-0 3Q lead and won by 25!!! GT has lost 4 straight after losing at home to BC 40-31 (-1'). ND is +35 ypg against while GT is -47 ypg and the Irish have ply'd the tougher sked (#1 vs #51). The Irish have a HUGE edge on D, holding foes 54 ypg below their avg while GT avg 38 ypg more than their foes allow and over their L/6 games GT has given up 544 ypg. ND is on a 7-1 ATS run with 5 straight covers and we've got the Irish winning by over 3 td's and after winning our GOY last week we don't mind going back to the Irish for our top Newsletter play! **FORECAST: NOTRE DAME by 24**

3★ WISCONSIN over Nebraska - UW is 10-4 in this series, have won 7 straight dating back to B10 Title in '12, and are 7-2 ATS S/'11. Neb is off a bye but QB Martinez (2516, 61%, 13/8, #2 rusher, 489 yds, 4.0, tm-high 12 TDs) has been playing w/ broken jaw and high-ankle sprain. The Badgers' 17-yr-old true frosh and converted DB Braelon Allen is making a late surge for All-B10 at RB as he's topped 100 yds in 6 straight gms after going off for 173 (6.9) on the ground LW in Wisconsin's dominating 35-7 home win (-24') over Northwestern that hit as a 4★ Late Phone Play for us as well as our Early Bird Comp (Free on Mondays, call 1-347-677-1700!) QB Mertz has rebounded tremendously to balance out the offense the L/2 gms (456, 74%, 5/2). Wisconsin is peaking at the right time as they've won 6 in a row SU and 5 straight gms ATS vs the B10 and control their own destiny in the B10 West. The Badgers' #1 D nationally (216 ypg) is immaculate and we see no let up for them on their way to Indianapolis. **FORECAST: WISCONSIN by 20**

3★ Oklahoma St over TEXAS TECH - Going back to '09 OSU is 10-2 SU vs TT but the Cowboys have failed to cover 6 of the L/7 gms incl 5 straight. OSU is off a 63-17 blowout win vs TCU (3★ newsletter winner upgraded to 4★ LP winner!). TT started frosh QB D.Smith (25-32-332) and upset ISU on a GW 62 yd FG as time expired. OSU's D has led their team all ssn as they are all'g just 262 ypg/15 ppg to B12 foes and are holding B12 foes to 156 ypg under their ssn avg. OSU's offense came to life LW though (724 yds incl 489 rush!) and face a TT D that has all'd 457 ypg/39 ppg vs B12 foes & are all'g B12 foes to gain 62 ypg above their ssn avg. Against common B12 foes OSU is +199 ypg/+23 ppg while TT is just +8 ypg/-4 ppg. While OSU has rival OU on deck, they still need to win to have a shot at the B12 title gm & we will ride OSU's 8-0 ATS hot streak & take them by over 2 td's. **FORECAST: Oklahoma St by 17**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ North Texas over FIU - These two haven't met since '14. NT is still alive for a bowl after beating UTEP 20-17 on a GW fg with :07 left. FIU has been dreadful, having lost 9 straight and are on a 0-5-1 ATS run including LW when they got ambushed by Middle Tenn 50-10 (+10'). The Panthers have lost their last 6 games by DD's (27.5 ppg). NT is +29 ypg and +100 ypg in their L/4 while FIU is -109 ypg and -199 ypg their L/4! It's hard to trust the Mean Green as road chalk but FIU is depleted (25 guys into LW) and Butch Davis' contract is about to expire with no signs of extension. The Panthers are going to be happy for this ssn to end while NT is showing fight and the Mean Green have won 3 straight including 2 on the road. **FORECAST: North Texas by 21**

2★ Michigan over MARYLAND - Michigan is one of the most well-balanced tms in America, w/ the ability to run (225 ypg), pass w/ McNamara (1883, 63%, 12/2), and play lights-out D (301 ypg all'd). The Wolverines gain 85 ypg more than their opponents normally allow (#1 in FBS) and their D holds tms to 93 yds below their avg output (#7 in FBS). W/ RB Corum out LW (778, 6.0), Haskins responded w/ 156 yds rushing (5.0) against a stout PSU run D (137 ypg, 3.5). OLB Ojabo and DE Hutchinson combined for 5 of Michigan's 7 sacks in their 21-17 win in Happy Valley (-2) and are now 1 and 2 in the B10 in sacks respectively. Maryland QB and B10 pass leader Tagovailoa has his work cut for him vs the Nations #9 pass D and Michigan wins by over 3 scores on their way to "The Game". **FORECAST: Michigan by 23**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 17TH

Central Michigan at BALL ST - CM has won 4 of L/6 mtgs but LY Ball St (E) won 45-20 with a 519-342 yd edge. LW, Ball St's 1 pt loss to NIU on a final play GW FG eliminated them from the MAC West race but they need a win to be bowl eligible. LW CM trailed Kent St 14-0 but won 54-30 to keep them 1 of 3 tms still alive in the MAC West race & are already bowl eligible. LW our Wed Night Marquee was an easy winner with over 50 in Toledo /BG that won with 9:27 left in 3Q. Call 1-800-654-3448 or visit ncsports.com for our Wednesday Night Marquee for just \$12.

Northern Illinois at BUFFALO - Huskies had won 12 straight in series until LY, when UB won 49-30 as a 13 pt AF despite just a 397-357 yd edge as they had 3 Def td's of 42+ yds. NIU has had 8 gms decided by 7 pts or less TY, winning 6 of them including a 1 pt win LW over Ball St. That win has them 1 win away from clinching the MAC West Title. LY Buffalo won the MAC East but this year need to win out just to be bowl eligible. Who will be out Wednesday Night Marquee winner? THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 18TH

Louisville at DUKE - Duke is 0-2 in this series and they've only met once as ACC foes back in '16. Duke's offense has been much better at home, avg 37 ppg while only putting up 12 ppg on the road after getting crushed 48-17 (+11) at Virginia Tech last week. Duke is -36 ppg and -264 ypg in their L/4 and their defense is giving up 109 ypg more than their foes avg (#127 in FBS). True frosh QB's Leonard and Moore played with QB Holmberg out with an injury. Louisville did the exact opposite last week, destroying Cuse at home 41-3 (-3) and held the Orange to 184 yds. QB Cunningham should be rested after only 7 carries last week. HC Cutcliffe is 20-14-1 as a HD. UL has played the toughest schedule (#33 vs #76) and a win makes them bowl eligible. FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 19TH

LOUISIANA TECH by 20 over Southern Miss - The dog has owned this series with 5 outright upsets in the last 6 meetings. LY Jay Hopson resigned as HC prior to ply'g LT and the Bulldogs got the GW td with :14 left to win 31-30 (+5). SM was 0-8 ATS vs FBS foes going into LW at unbeaten UTSA. HC Hall said they decided to "milk the clock and reduce the game". They used RB's Willis and Gore at QB and the plan worked as they were tied 17-17 4Q and only lost by 10 pts as 32' pt dogs. LT ended a 5 gm losing streak, beating Char 42-32 (-7). The Bulldogs started their 3rd different QB in the L/3 gms with QB Allen throwing for 324 and 2 td's. LT has ply'd the tougher schedule (#67 vs #115) and although the Bulldogs can't goto a bowl, they will be motivated to beat their rival on Senior Day and SM's new strategy won't be a surprise now.

HOUSTON by 8 over Memphis - While Hou leads the series 15-14, the Tigers have clawed past the Cougars 5 yrs in a row while covering 6 straight. LTH ('19), Memphis was off a top-15 win vs SMU and experienced no let down as they blasted Houston w/ a 531-256 yd edge and were +15 in FD en route to a 45-27 win (-10). More than half the D has started every gm for the Tigers, and their continuity is paying off as they're all'g just 356 ypg of total offense in their L/5 gms. Houston is enjoying a stretch where they are coming off AAC bottom feeders Temple and USF (combined 2-10 in AAC) and have a trip to UCONN on deck. We feel Memphis is stiff enough to keep this to single-digits.

WASHINGTON ST by 20 over Arizona - WSU won 7 straight ATS prior to LW's push against the Ducks as a 14 pt dog. The Wildcats meanwhile head into Pullman following a 9 pt home loss to the Utes where they actually led in the 2Q despite being a 24 pt dog. Wazzou has won 4 of the L/6 in this series including the L/2 here. LTH ('18) they picked up an easy 69-28 (-10') win with former QB Minshew breaking the school record with 7 TD passes. While this will be the first time that the Cougars are favored during this recent ATS run, a trip to the cold and potentially rainy palouse is never good for a warm-weathered program (Wildcats are 7-18 ATS as an AD).

NEVADA by 6 Air Force - AF has won 3 of the 5 mtgs as MW foes. The last mtg was back in '18 when Nev (+3') pulled the road upset 28-25. Nev is off a 23-21 loss at SDSt (2★ newsletter winner Nev +3) while AF is off a 35-21 road win at CSU (3★ LP winner!). AF comes in all'g just 184 pass ypg (56%) but they have all'd 448 pass to Utah St & 259 pass to Boise and now face a Nev pass attack that is avg'g 389 ypg (73%) the L/4 gms. AF's run gm is avg'g 324 ypg (5.1) vs MW foes but Nev has been solid vs the run (129, 4.2 vs MW foes) however they haven't seen the option since facing AF in '18. Against MW foes Nev is +31 ypg/+10 ppg while AF is +88 ypg/+8 ppg. NV also has a huge ST's edge (#11 vs #120!) Nev is on a 6-2 ATS run as a MW HF & we think the Pack's strong pass gm propels them to victory.

San Diego St by 17 over UNLV - While SDSt is 7-2 SU vs UNLV in the L/9 gms, the Rebels have covered 5 times as dogs incl pulling 2 upsets. LY SDSt won 34-6 & held UNLV to 186 yds (15 yds in 1H). SDSt enters off a 23-21 win vs SDSt while UNLV is off a rivalry gm win vs Hawaii & have won 2 straight. UNLV is avg'g just 349 yds the L/4 gms & are getting held to 53 ypg under what their foes typically allow. They face a SDSt D that is all'g just 317 ypg vs MW foes & holds them to 71 ypg under their ssn avg. SDSt's run D holds foes to 83 ypg (3.1) and their pass D ranks #13. While SDSt is avg'g 308 ypg/19 ppg the L/4 gms, they face a UNLV D all'g 415 ypg/30 ppg at home & they give up 69% pass comp overall. SDSt also has a huge edge in ST's (#2 vs #114). We see SDSt's D locking down UNLV here & their offense will do enough to get them the road win.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 20TH

PITTSBURGH by 20 over Virginia - Pitt is 4-1 SU although they didn't meet LY due to Covid. UVA will see a much different Kenny Pickett than when they faced him in '19's opener, his first game under OC Whipple when Pitt lost 30-14. Now Pickett is in his 3rd year under Whipple and one of the top QB's in CFB (3517, 68%, 32-4). Last week Pitt led 17-0 1Q but needed OT to beat NCAR 30-23 (-6') giving us a Thurs Night Marquee winner! We knew QB Armstrong was unlikely to play LW vs Notre Dame (ribs) so we made the call to go against the Cavaliers for our 5★ GOY! True Frosh Woolfolk made his first career start. UVA (+6') trailed 28-0 3Q and finished with just 278 yds in 25 pt loss! Armstrong is still a ? to return. This game likely decides the ACC Coastal and we will take Pickett at home, plus Pitt has a huge edge on D, allowing 348 ypg while UVA has all'd 512 ypg in their L/8!

ARMY by 42 over Massachusetts - Knights are 3-0 SU & 1-0 ATS all-time vs UMass scoring 34+ pts in all 3 mtgs, Army has outscored UMass by a combined 131-44 incl a 63-7 (-34) in 2019. UMass is off 2 straight losses to FCS teams losing 35-22 to Rhode Island that cost HC Bell his job & then 35-10 LW to Maine. UMass is allowing 224 ypg tush & 5.7 ypg & have lost 4 straight SU & ATS. It is not a question if Army will win but by how much. This is Army's home finale & they are off a 63-10 win over Bucknell as a 51' pt HF so we think they will cover here..

UCF by 35 over UConn - The Knights are 5-2 all-time and have won 4 straight. While the Huskies are 4-2 ATS S/'14, they've been roughly 36-pt dogs in their L/3 w/ UCF. UCONN is the worst tm in FBS and arguably the worst program, as they are 10-48 (.172) S/ making a bowl gm in '15 and have been DD dogs vs every FBS tm not named UMSS S/'18. TY they are #128 in FBS as they've all'd 105 yds more than opponents avg and are #129 in FBS as their anemic offense avg's 113 yds less than their opps all's on avg. C'mon. The Knights by 5 TDs.

MIAMI, FL by 3 over Virginia Tech - Miami has won 3 of the last 4 meetings but the home team is 0-3 SU/ATS. LY VT (-2) led 14-3 2Q and never trailed until 5:56 left. The Hokies L/5 possessions ended in punt/punt/int/punt/SOD and 'Canes won 25-24. Miami was one play away from beating FSU LW but allowed 4th & 15 conversion then GW td w/:26 left which cost us our 4★ top newsletter play. VT got QB Burreister back LW and crushed Duke at home 48-17 (-11). QB Van Dyke has thrown for 364 ypg in his L/5 but VT has our #19 pass D. The Hokies have 5 outright upsets under Fuente including LTH in '19 and Miami is 0-7 as a HF vs FBS foes. The 'Canes last 6 games have all been decided by 4 pts or fewer so it's hard to imagine laying 7 pts here.

NC STATE by 14 over Syracuse - NCSt has won 6 of the last 7 mtgs but Cuse is 5-2 ATS. LY Cuse was just 1-8 and +15' but led 29-27 4Q. NCSt led 36-29 and got a SOD on the NCSt 18 on the final possession. Cuse had covered 7 straight gms until they were dominated last week at Lville 41-3 (+3). The Orange trailed 35-3 at half and finished w/just 184 yds. NCSt enters off a 45-42 (+1') loss at WF. NCSt is 4-1 ATS at home and is +120 ypg at home while Cuse is -9 ypg on the road. QB Leary has a 30-5 ratio and has 337 pass ypg his L/4. Cuse's pass D is only #103 and has all'd a 16-3 ratio. The Wolfpack are holding foes 70 ypg below their avg and only gave up 406 LW vs WF's potent offense. The Pack have the edge in all 3 phases and 5 of their 7 wins are by double-digits.

Kent St by 12 over AKRON - These rivals play for the Wagon Wheel Trophy. After a 4 gm series Zip winning streak, Kent St has won & covered L/2. LY Flashes were a 26' pt HF & won 69-35 outgaining the Zips 750-366. LW after firing their HC, Zips despite being a 24' pt AD took a 40-38 lead with 2:22 left but allowed a GW td w/1:00 to lose 45-40 to WM. We had an easy Tues Night Marquee winner on over 62 in that game. LW Kent St despite only being outgained 505-456 lost 54-30 to CM as a 2' pt AD. They fired their DC 2 days later. Against 4 common foes Kent St is 3-1 SU while Akron is 1-3 SU. Both are 2-2 ATS but KS was favored in 3 while Akron was a dog in all 4. A win in this rivalry would be Akron's only bright spot this ssn. While a win would make KS bowl eligible, next week's gm vs Miami will likely decide the MAC East, even if they lose here.

OHIO ST by 25 over Michigan St - Ohio St is 5-0 SU w/4 straight covers (twice as 20' + pt favs). These two have played 5 common foes, w/OSU is +34 ppg/+229 ypg while Michigan St is just +7 ppg/-32 ypg thanks in largely to Ohio St's #1 offense (550 ypg) and Sparty's suspect D (444 ypg)! The Buckeye offense is so dynamic that Jaxson Smith-Njigba, the #3 option in the pass gm, has exploded onto the scene (1027, 17.4) and is within striking distance of becoming the all-time leader for receiving yds in a ssn at Ohio St. WR Chris Olave has a receiving TD in 7 straight gms, which leads the FBS, and Garrett Wilson returned LW to score 4 total TDs (126, 12.6). We see the Bucks by more than 3 TDs here.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 21 over Texas St - Met 3 prior times as SBC foes with CC winning the L/2 incl LY when CC (-17) won easily 49-17 (35-7, 372-140 HT edge). CC is still playing w/o QB McCall & LW lost to GST 42-40 while TXSt lost to GSThrn 38-30 at home. The L/4 gms TXSt's run D has all'd 199 ypg (4.4) and now face a CC rush attack that is putting up 212 ypg (5.5) vs SBC foes. CC this ssn at home has held foes to 295 ypg/19 ppg & are +228 ypg/+29 ppg while TXSt is putting up just 308 ypg/15 ppg on the road & are -147 ypg/-22 ppg on the road. Against 4 common SBC foes CC is +154 ypg/+20 ppg while TXSt is -48 ypg/-4 ppg. CC also has the big edge on ST's (#3 vs #82). Even w/o McCall we still see CC's offense overpowering TXSt & winning by 3 td's.

Florida by 7 over MISSOURI - In '18 MO upset Florida in the Swamp but the Gators have dominated the last 2 mtgs, winning by 17 & 24, holding Mizzou to 256 & 248 yds in those. FL fired DC Grantham before ply'g FCS Samford LW but that didn't fix their issues as they allowed 530 yds and 52 pts in an 18 pt win. QB Jones did have a career high 6 td's. MO has covered 2 straight after beat SCar 31-28 (E) and the Tigers had a +188 yd edge and allowed a ssn low 250 yds. Mizzou's much maligned D might actually have the edge here, allowing 392 ypg in their L/4 while FL has all'd 449 the L/4. RB Badie had 209 rush LW and FL all'd 284 rush vs SC & 321 vs LSU this year. Things just aren't right in Gainesville and UF is 1-7 as an AF. A win here makes Mizzou bowl eligible so they keep it within a td.

WEST VIRGINIA by 3 over Texas - Tex has won 3 of the L/4 mtgs SU but the home team has failed to cover in all 4 mtgs. Tex is off a stunning 57-56 OT loss vs KU (+154 yds, -4 TO's) while WVU lost 34-17 vs KSt (+44 ypg, -3 TO's). Tex RB Robinson is banged up but played LW, but he faces a WVU rush D that has all'd 163 (4.7) the L/4 gms. Tex's D is concerning (465 ypg/38 ppg all'd vs B12 foes) and WVU did put up 492 on Iowa St at home earlier this ssn. Tex does have the #98 pass D and QB Doege is hitting 66%. Against 6 common B12 foes Tex is -60 ypg/-1 ppg while WVU is -27 ypg/-6 ppg. Tex is in complete free fall (-0.5 SU/ATS slide) and WVU is 7-3 ATS in their L/10 home gms.

TENNESSEE by 34 over South Alabama - Only prior mtg was in '13 when Vols (-13') were backdoored, leading 31-7 3Q but only won by a td. A win here makes HC Heupel the first Vols coach to get Tenn to a bowl in his first year since Lane Kiffin. SA is playing their 3rd straight road game after losing B2B games. SA only trailed 14-7 at half LW at App St with QB Trotter making his first start of the ssn. Tenn led UGA 10-7 2Q LW but the offense didn't score again until 4th qtr and the Vols lost 41-17 (+20). The Vols have played a way tougher schedule (#43 vs #130) and have one of the most explosive offense's in the country, putting up 107 ypg more than their foes allow. Heupel is known for blowing out non-bowl teams going back to his days as OC at Mizzou so we like Tenn by over 4 tds.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 10 over Florida St - FSU is 9-1 SU in this series and have covered 4 of the L/5 including the last mtg in '19. This is actually the 3rd straight mtg that FSU has been the dog vs BC. QB Jurkovec looked more like himself in LW's 41-30 (+1) win at GT, throwing for 310 and 2 td's. FSU led Miami 20-0 2Q but trailed 28-23 and got a 1st down on 4th&15 to set up GW td w/26 left. The 'Noles are -2 ypg while BC is +34 ypg but FSU has played a much tougher schedule (#67 vs #117). FSU needs to win out to reach a bowl but we are only 2-5 as an AD. BC has won B2B games now and is 3-0 ATS when Jurkovec plays a full game so we are taking the Eagles by over a fg.

LIBERTY by 3 over Louisiana - These non-conf foes have met once before as FBS foes & that was back in '19 when LA (-14) hosted LU and won 35-14. LU comes into this gm off a bye & have 7 wins on the ssn while LA has locked up the SBC West Div. With dynamic QB Willis LU's offense is avg'g 450 yds the L/4 gms & here they face a Cajuns pass D ranked #58. The Cajuns bread & butter on offense is their run game (234, 5.2 the L/4 gms) and they take a LU run D allowing 184 (4.2) the L/4 gms. These tms have 1 common foe in Troy and LU won at Troy 21-13 (+107 yds) while LA won 35-21 (-21 yds, +2 TO's). We expect a competitive gm, but LA may not risk too much here with the SBC title gm coming up & we think LU takes it by a FG.

Purdue by 16 over Northwestern - While NW has won 8 of the L/10 and are 4-1 ATS S/'15, Purdue is 51-33-1 all-time and both tms are in much different places than in recent history. The Boilers have a strong chance to finish the reg ssn w/ 8 wins for the first time in 25 yrs, while NW clinched just their second losing ssn in the L/7 LW in a gm they were outgained 239-497 and lost the FD edge 12-24 35-7 at Wisconsin (+24), losing 35-7. The Wildcats are terrible on D, all'g 450 ypg vs the B10 and 63 yds more than their opponents avg (#113 in FBS), and their offense has put up just 269 ypg in their L4 gms. Purdue still managed 481 yds LW in Columbus (390 yds passing) and we don't think NW has the horses to hang w/ O'Connell or Bell and lose by more than 2 TDs.

Minnesota by 4 over INDIANA - The Golden Gophers are 39-26-3 all-time vs Indiana, are 9-3 ATS S/'97, and have covered 3 straight. The Hoosiers are the most disappointing tm in college football, as they were ranked #17 pre-season, but are the only winless tm in their conf at 0-7. Indiana is 1-8 ATS vs the FBS TY and LW all'd sputtering Rutgers (-7), who were on a 1-5 SU and 1-4 ATS skid, to come into their house and leave w/ everything but the kitchen sink (lost 38-3), but actually were only outgained by 58 yds and the biggest issue was their 6 TO's (all'd td drives of 21, 10 & 39 yds). It's Senior Day in Bloomington and we think they limit the turnovers and keep this within a touchdown.

PENN ST by 21 over Rutgers - The Nittany Lions are 29-2 vs Rutgers and have won 14 straight gms dating back to 1989. The Scarlet Knights are 3-1 ATS S/'17, but none of those wins have come as less than 4 TD dogs. Rutgers was on a 1-4 SU/ATS decline before heading to Bloomington (+7), where the Hoosiers gift wrapped the game for them (6 TO's) once and for all in a 38-3 win, so it's hard to decipher the level of competitiveness Penn St will face from their opponent TW. The Nittany Lions likely work to fix their broken run gm here (108, 3.2) and we like them to do so by 3 TDs in Happy Valley.

Wake Forest by 3 over CLEMSON - Clem has won the L/12 mtgs but WF is 5-2 ATS against the Tigers. This game likely decides the ACC Atlantic. Clemson is off an easy 44-7 (-41) win over UConn while WF won yet another shootout, 45-42 (-1) vs NCSU. The 'Pack were missing their top 2 CB's and their #2 WR Robinson left w/an inj. Total contrast here with Clemson having a huge edge on defense while WF has the edge on offense. The Deacons do rate the edge on ST's as well but Clemson has played the tougher schedule. Ultimately the difference in this game is at QB where Hartman (60%, 30-8) should easily outplay Uigalelei (55%, 8-7) and WF has a veteran OLine that should have all'd just 16 sacks this year which is huge when ply'g Clemson's talented Dline (33 sks). Clemson is 2-8 ATS this year while WF is 15-6 as an AD.

WKU by 10 over Fau - This should be a much more exciting game than LY's snooze-fest which was tied 0-0 at half and FAU won 10-6. Toppers have lost L/4 series mtgs. Both tms are led by transfer QB's who have played well in WKU's Zappe (71%, 42-7) and FAU's Perry (59%, 17-4). FAU is off B2B losses after falling at ODU 30-16 (-6) and was out'd 454-308 and out FD'd 12-13. WKU is off a 42-21 (-19) win over Rice. They led 28-0 at half w/a 370-218 yd edge. WKU avg 41 ppg and 521 ypg. The 'Toppers are +80 ypg at home while FAU is -115 ypg on the road and is 1-4 SU/2-3 ATS on the

road. WKU has won 5 straight by 23.6 ppg and are on a 4-0-1 ATS run but FAU has our #23 ranked pass D (55%, 12-11) and need a win for bowl eligibility so our lean is with the dog.

IOWA by 9 over Illinois - The Fighting Illini lead the all-time series 38-36-2 and both tms' last gm were wins over Minnesota. While Illinois was -24 in yds and -3 in FD in a 14-6 outright upset win on the road (+14'), the Hawkeyes were outgained 409-277 and lost the FD edge 12-23 LW, winning by the slimmer margin of 27-22 (-4). Iowa held a 24-22 lead w/ under a min to play and used a 29-yd FG for the frontdoor cover to narrowly avoid their 4th consecutive ATS loss. The Illini are off a bye here and off their last bye, they traveled to Happy Valley (+24) and ran through Penn St for a 20-18 outright upset in 9OT. Illinois has avg'd 271 yds rushing their L/2 road gms and QB Peters has been efficient in his L/2 starts (270, 75%, 3/0). We like the Illini to keep this to single-digits.

BOISE ST by 34 over New Mexico - Since 2011 Boise is 8-1 SU against NMEx & after going 0-5 ATS from '11-'15 Boise has covered 3 of the L/4 gms incl their last mtg back in '19 when Boise (-27) dominated 42-9 (509-292) at home. Boise has won 3 straight off their bye & now face a NMEx tm that is just 1-9 ATS TY and they are avg'g just 208 ypg/10 ppg against MW foes. Boise's offense avg's 411 ypg vs MW foes but NMEx has a solid D, all'g 364 ypg vs MW foes. On the road NMEx is -141 ypg/-16 ppg & against 4 common MW foes Boise is +58 ypg/+10 ppg while NMEx is -196 ypg/-18 ppg. We see Boise having little trouble in this game & winning by over 4 tds.

UTAH by 7 over Oregon - Huge matchup in the P12 between a pair of squads that could possibly meet again in the Conf Championship in a few weeks. The Ducks continue to hold a high spot in the playoff standings following a 14 pt win over WSU. The Utes meanwhile picked up a 9 pt road win LW in Tucson finishing with 2616 FD and 468-329 yd edges. Ironically, these two last met in the '19 P12 Championship where Utah suffered its 2nd loss in the title game in as many years (JU 37-15 win, +6'). With potential revenge on their mind from that defeat and a 17-8 ATS mark in recent conf matchups, we'll go and call for Utah to end Oregon's playoff chances in this one (Ducks have failed to cover 8 of their L/12 as an AD).

Washington by 7 over COLORADO - Following a narrow home loss to the Sun Devils where they led 24-14 heading into the 4Q (ASU 376-266 yd edge), the Huskies are back on the road for the 1st time in 3 wks to take on a Buffs squad that blew a 20-10 HT lead LW in Pasadena against the Bruins (UCLA 34-0 run in the 2H!). While Washington has won 9 of the L/10 in this series including an impressive 8-2 ATS mark, the Buffs did come away with the outright upset win in their most recent meeting (20-14 victory as a 14' pt dog at Boulder in '19). Prior to the defeat UW had won all 7 P12 meetings by DD (29 pt avg MOV). While the Buffs are 6-3 ATS as a HD coming in, the Huskies just fired HC Lake, but they do need a win here followed by a victory in the Apple Cup to become eligible for a bowl.

STANFORD by 3 over California - The first time these 2 academic powers met in the "Big Game" was back in 1892! The Bears head into Palo Alto after seeing their matchup against USC postponed due to Covid issues in Berkeley. The Cardinal meanwhile dropped a 21 pt matchup LW to the Beavers in Corvallis with true frosh QB Patu getting his 1st career start (7-14-51-1-1) for the inj'd McKee. Stanford has won 10 of the L/11 matchups (24-23 LY, bk'd Cal's game-tying PAT) but did see their 9-gm win streak end in '19 on "The Farm" with the Bears (+1) picking up the 24-20 victory. With the Cardinal needing to rebound here following a 5-game losing streak and covering 7 of the L/11 as a HD, a win here could do wonders for HC Shaw's future.

OREGON ST by 3 over Arizona St - After an easy 21 pt win over the Cardinal where we picked up a 3★ LP Winner (OSU 29-15 FD & 475-230 yd edges), the Beavers are back in Corvallis for a 2nd consecutive week to take on a Sun Devils team that needed a strong 4Q performance (3 TD's in the final 6 minutes) to escape Seattle with a 5 pt win. While OSU has won 6 of the past 8 home meetings with ASU, the 2 defeats have come over the past 3 contests including LY when the Beavers (+7) allowed 375 rush yds (8.9 ypc) in a 46-33 defeat. With the Sun Devils struggling in cold weather (dressed 5 of the L/7 outright from Oct-Dec when traveling to CO, OR, UT & WA) along with failing to cover 8 of their L/11 as an AF, we're giving the Beavers (7-1 ATS run at home) a good shot to pick up the win here.

USC by 4 over UCLA - Following a postponed matchup against Cal due to some Covid issues in Berkeley, the Trojans return home still needing to do some work to become bowl eligible. The Bruins meanwhile accomplished that feat a week ago at home against the Buffs with a huge 2H where they outscored CU 34-0! USC has won 5 of their past 6 meetings against UCLA coming in (4-2 ATS) and 10 of their L/11 here (8-3 ATS). LY's trip to Pasadena saw USC QB Slovis throw for a school-record 515 yds and 4 TD's including a GW TD pass with '16 left in a 43-38 (-3) win. While the Bruins have won and covered 3 of their 4 P12 AG's so far in '21, prior series history, extra rest and bowl need should be enough for the Trojans to escape with a win here.

East Carolina by 7 over NAVY - ECU are money making machines, on a 7-0 ATS run vs the FBS w/ 6 straight ATS wins ovr and a 3-gm win streak SU. They're fresh off cashing our Underdog Play of the Week after hitting as our Top Key Selection and a 3★ Late Phone Play in B2B wks. They've gotten it done by running the ball (FR RB Mitchell leads the AAC in rushing yds w/ 983) and playing solid D (have all'd over 400 yds of offense just once in conf and are all'g just 320 ypg in AAC). While ECU has struggled stopping the triple-option (all'd 361 ypg L/3Y), they've improved each yr against it under HC Houston. Navy ripped off 3 in a row ATS after their last bye earlier TY including an outright upset, and while that's to be noted, we'll ride the Pirate ship again this week by 7 pts.

Over 39 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years and we've now had 4 outright winners after East Carolina beat Memphis LW!! Here is This week's Underdog Play:

Smu +12 over CINCINNATI

The Bearcats were w/o the AAC's #2 leading rusher in Jerome Ford LW (884, 6.2), and while QB Ridder had his best gm of the ssn (304, 80%, 2/1 w/ 65 yds rushing and a TD), it was not enough to keep Cincy from dropping their 4th straight ATS. SMU got RB Bentley back as we told you in these pages LW despite his "uncertain" status, and he put up 124 all-purpose yds in a 55-28 route of UCF at home (-7). Bentley is the x-factor for the high-powered SMU offense (499 ypg) as he has avg'd 113 ypg on the ground in the 4 gms he has been full-go vs the FBS TY. With SMU's AAC title gm hopes still hanging in the balance, we like them to battle tough, and Cincy has failed to cover against the bottom of the AAC, now steps up to playing the top of the conference and is still laying double-digits.

Auburn by 7 over SOUTH CAROLINA - We won our Underdog POW and a 3★ LPS LY when SC pulled the outright upset, 30-22 (+3). Aub led 28-3 2Q but their D allowed td's on 6 straight possessions and Aub didn't score again until 3:37 4Q in 9 pt loss. SC still needs a win to get bowl elig after losing 31-28 (E) at Mizzou. SC only put up 250 yds and struggled to run against one of the SEC's worst D's. Normally we play against Bo Nix on the road but he's OFY (ankle) so LSU transfer TJ Finley takes over. Auburn has Bama on deck but SC's win against Florida doesn't look so impressive. We aren't sure what to do with this game so we put it at the line and will see where the line moves.

TULSA by 26 over Temple - This is the first mtg in 33 yrs where Tulsa will be favored over the Owls, and for good reason. Temple is 1-7 ATS in their L/8 gms and on an 0-5 SU/ATS nosedive where they've been outscored 217-35. The Owls currently sit at 10th in the AAC, and while the 'Canes are middle of the pack, they're returning home off B2B ATS wins on the road and welcome a tm who is 1-4 SU/ATS as visitors TY. The Owls were w/o their starting QB LW, not that it mattered (avg'g 230 ypg of total offense in their L/5 outings). Temple has largely been an embarrassment TY and we like Tulsa by 4 scores.

Appalachian St by 14 over TROY - Since App St moved to the FBS they are 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS incl winning & covering 3 straight vs Troy. App St is off a 31-7 win vs SAla while Troy lost 35-21 to LA (+21 yds, -3 TO's). Troy's run D has been solid vs SBC foes TY (144, 3.5) but App St is putting up 220 rush ypg (5.2) the L/4 gms. Troy's offense is nothing special & are avg'g 357 ypg but App St's D holds SBC foes to 64 ypg under their season avg. Troy's pass attack avg's 257 ypg in conf play but they are going against App St's pass D which ranks #24. Against 4 common SBC foes App St is +44 ypg/+8 ppg while Troy is -10 ypg/-7 ppg. App St has the stronger offense (#45 vs #111) & defense (#39 vs #63) & ST's (#18 vs #125) and we think they eventually pull away & win by 2 td's.

MISSISSIPPI by 34 over Vanderbilt - Ole Miss is 6-2 SU and has covered 3 of the last 4 meetings. Rebels have won last 2 mtgs by 33 and 25 and were only laying 17' and 7' in those games. Vandy gave up 641 yds in LY's game and this 'Dores D hasn't been any better, allowing 459 ypg and 96 ypg more than their foes avg. Vandy is coming off a 34-17 (+21'). QB Seals ret'd from injury but only threw for 87 yds. KY led 31-3 at half but they only had 4 2H possessions while chewing clock which let Vandy get a backdoor cover. Ole Miss is off a 29-19 (+2) win over A&M. The Rebels only led 15-13 when they got a 14 yd td drive then a pick 6 to blow it open. Ole Miss is 4-1 as a HF this year but they have the Egg Bowl with short rest on deck so we think Vandy stays within 5 td's.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 10 over Old Dominion - MT is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series, winning all 4 by DD's (24.8 avg MOV). HC Stockstill said they still had faith in frosh QB Vacciato after he threw 5 int's the week prior vs WKU. Vacciato played much better against FIU, hitting 20-24 for 147 and 2 td's as MT won 50-10 (-10'), finishing w/a 414-155 yd edge. ODU has now won 3 straight after upsetting FAU 30-16 (+6). The Monarchs D recorded 3 two-pt plays LW and actually led 4-3 2Q after their 2nd safety. MT is 4-0 SU/ATS and +49 ypg at home while ODU is -60 ypg on the road. The Blue Raiders need a win to get bowl eligible and we've got them pulling this one out by more than a touchdown.

ALABAMA by 27 over Arkansas - Bama has won 14 straight meetings including LY when they led 38-3 at half w/a 226-70 yd edge and won by 49. Ark hasn't topped 14 pts in their last 6 trips to Tuscaloosa. Bama is fresh after covering the largest FBS line of the ssn, beating NMST 59-3 (-51'). Ark is play'g B2B road games after beating LSU 16-13 (-3) in Baton Rouge. Bama is 10-1 as a HF and while Ark much prefers the dog role under Pittman they do already have a 37-0 loss at UGA on their resume this year. Saban will want his team confident going into the Iron Bowl so they won't take it easy on Arkansas so we like the Tide to cover the early 20' point line.

LSU by 24 over Ulm - Since '03 these tms have met 3 times & LSU has won all 3 by a comb'd score of 131-7. LSU has slim hopes of a bowl gm left but need a win here & next week vs A&M while ULM has exceeded expectations this ssn with 4 wins. ULM's D is allowing 517 ypg/48 ppg in road games TY but LSU's offense has only put up 346 ypg/23 ppg the L/4 gms. LSU's D is all'g just 299 ypg vs non-conf foes & ULM's offense is putting up just 234 ypg/18 ppg vs non-conf foes. While we like LSU to win, this is a large spread and The Tigers are dealing with a lot of issues with inj's & this gm is essentially meaningless for LSU, plus HC Bowden will have ULM ready to play.

Tulane by 3 over USF - A tickle fight between 2 of the bottom 3 tms in AAC, who have combined for 1 FBS win TY (USF beat the other bottom 3 tm at home, Temple, 34-14). The Bulls are 4-1 ATS since their bye but just 1-3 ATS on the road. When you're as bad as Tulane, you begin inventing ways to lose. LW at home vs Tulsa (+3), the Wave erased a 10-pt deficit in the final 3 mins and were gifted a late INT to set up a 26-yd potential GW FG w/ 0:00, but missed wide right and lost in OT 20-13. We see USF keeping it to a FG.

OKLAHOMA by 7 over Iowa St - ISU has just 7 SU wins in 86 gms vs OU but 2 of those wins are in the L5Y incl LY in the reg ssn when ISU (+7) pulled the upset. ISU has also covered 5 of the L/6 mtgs. OU is off a shocking 27-14 loss at BU while ISU lost 41-38 at TT on a 62-yd FG on the last play. Over the F/5 gms OU's run D all'd 99 ypg (2.6) but over the L/5 gms that jumped to 176 ypg (4.6) & ISU avg's 184 (5.5) vs B12 foes. However OU's offense is avg'g 431 ypg/38 ppg the L/4 gms & is much better with QB Williams in there and they face an ISU D that was strong to start the ssn but has all'd 492 yds/38 pts & 529 yds/41 pts in their L/2 road gms. Against common B12 foes ISU is +109 ypg/+13 ppg while OU is +67 ypg/+8 ppg. OU still controls their own destiny to reach the B12 title gm & with the line being under a TD we think the Sooners bounce back & win by a TD.

TCU by 21 over Kansas - Since joining the B12 TCU is 8-1 SU vs B12 foes & after failing to cover 5 straight from '12-'16 TCU has covered 3 of the L/4 gms incl LY when TCU (-24) won 59-23. TCU has slim hopes for a bowl (lost 63-17 at OSU LW) while KU is off a shocking 57-56 OT upset win at Tex as a 31-pt dog! In B12 gms this ssn KU is -228 ypg/-29 ppg & are all'g 512 ypg/47 ppg in conf play. However TCU's D has not been the same TY as they are all'g 498 ypg/38 ppg vs B12 foes. TCU's offense switched to QB Morris & he should take advantage of a KU pass D ranked #129 & all'g 70% completions to B12 foes. Against common B12 foes TCU is -65 ypg/-11 ppg while KU is -222 ypg/-31 ppg. While we think TCU wins by 3 td's, they are just 2-7-1 ATS TY & have major injury issues at RB.

KENTUCKY by 31 over New Mexico St - KY won the only prior meeting 62-42 (-21') in '16. The Aggies are playing their 2nd straight SEC 'money game' after getting smoked at Bama LW as 51' pt dogs, 59-3. KY led 31-3 at half vs Vandy but only had 4 2H possessions while they chewed clock

NMST is 1-9 but actually better than their record indicates, having led both San Diego St and Utah St at half. KY is on a 6-2 ATS run vs non-conf foes but prior they were 5-14 ATS vs non-conf and Stoops is just 2-5 ATS as 30+ chalk.

Marshall by 21 over CHARLOTTE - Marshall is off for revenge for '19's upset road loss, 24-13 (-7). UC needs a win to get bowl elig after losing at LA Tech 42-32 (+7). The 49ers held a 548-504 yd edge but was SOD at the LT 1 and 34. MU enters off an upset loss at home against UAB 21-14 (-5). The Herd put up a ssn low 269 yds. MU must win to set up next week's game vs WKU for the CUSA East Title. MU is +92 ypg and all but 1 of their 6 wins have come by 16 pts or more. UC is -56 ypg and all 5 of their losses have come by DD's. The 49ers allow 202 (5.3) rush ypg and MU has RB Ali (939, 5.1, 17 td's). QB Wells only has a 13-2 ratio but UC is #124 in pass D and we like the Herd by 3 td's.

UTSA by 7 over UAB - UAB has won 4 straight mtgs but LY UTSA was +21 and only lost 21-13. UTSA probably didn't expect SMiss to go in full clock burn mode and play their RB's in Wildcat the entire game which partly explains why they trailed 17-10 3Q. UTSA did finish w/a 370-189 yd edge and won by 10. UAB won at Marshall 21-14 (+5) LW, holding the Herd to a ssn low 269 yds. The Blazers have the edge on D, holding foes to 321 ypg and 55 ypg below their avg but UTSA has the edge on offense, putting up 446 ypg and 55 ypg more than their foes allow. QB Harris has a 20-5 ratio and 400 rush and UAB did struggle with dual threat QB's earlier TY. The Roadrunners are playing with unbeaten pressure but should give an A+ effort to get Traylor his first division title but UAB is a dangerous dog.

BYU by 4 over KANSAS ST - BU has won 7 of the L/9 mtgs SU and the home team has failed to cover the L/5 gms. BU is off an upset win over OU 27-14 (held OU to 260 yds) while KSt won 34-17 vs WVU despite being -47 yds (+3 TO's + a blk'd punt ret'd for TD). BU's rush offense has been a big key for their offense TY & they are running for 245 ypg (5.6) but KSt has done well stopping the run on their 4 gm win streak as they are all'g just 123 (3.6). BU's OL has done an excellent job (8 sks all'd all ssn) but here they face a KSt pass rush that has 27 sks overall incl 11 in their L/4 gms. Against common B12 foes BU is +41 ypg/+11 ppg while KSt is -7 ypg/+5 ppg. While BU is off an emotional win, they are on a 7-2 ATS run & we think they get a close win here in Manhattan.

GEORGIA ST by 24 over Arkansas St - As SBC foes Ark St is 6-1 SU & more recently the home tm is on a 3 gm SU/ATS win streak. GSt is off an upset win over Coastal 42-40 (-69 yds but +2 TO's that led to 14 pts) while Ark St got their first win vs an FBS tm TY as they beat ULM 27-24. GSt has been outgained in their L/3 gms, but have won 4 of their L/5 gms thanks to a +8 TO margin in the L/5 gms & against SBC foes Ark St is -8 TO's. GSt's rush attack has been strong all ssn (217, 4.9) and against SBC foes it's 230 (5.0) and here they face an Ark St rush D that is all'g 306 rush ypg (7.0) to SBC foes! Against SBC foes GSt is -15 ypg/+4 ppg while Ark St is -141 ypg/-18 ppg and the Ark St D is all'g foes to gain 163 ypg above their ssn avg (#130 FBS!). GSt is on a 7-1 ATS run & we like the Panthers to cruise to a home win by over 3 td's!

UTEP by 7 over Rice - The home team is 0-3 SU/ATS in this series. They didn't meet LY and Rice won in '19 30-16 (-6'). Things have gone off the rails for UTEP since getting bowl eligible, losing 3 straight after falling at NT 20-17 (-1). Rice trailed 28-0 at half vs WKU LW in a game that saw 9 TO's and WKU had td drives of 39, 34 & 23. Rice is just 2-8 ATS this year and this is UTEP's last real chance to guarantee a bowl by getting to 7 wins (UAB on deck). UTEP is +56 ypg and Rice is -79 ypg, though Rice has play'd a tougher schedule (#68 vs #129). We aren't ready to lay double-digits on UTEP so our lean is with the dog and Rice did win at UAB earlier TY.

BYU by 27 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - First meeting. GSthrn is going through a tough ssn with just 3 wins while BYU is the opposite, sitting at 8-2 SU this ssn. BYU does have to travel cross country but are off a bye & just faced an FCS tm 2 wks ago. The last time BYU faced a true option tm was LY's opener vs Navy & they held them to 119 rush yds (3.1). This ssn BYU is all'g 146 rush ypg (4.8) & GSthrn's rush game has only avg'd 144 ypg (3.3) the L/4 gms. GSthrn's pass D has struggled this ssn (#119) and they face a BYU pass attack that is putting up 306 ypg (67%) the L/4 gms. We like a fresh BYU team to go on the road & get a big win.

UTAH ST by 9 over Wyoming - Since '11 USU is 6-2 SU vs WY but have failed to cover 3 of the L/4 gms. USU leads the Mountain Div currently but needs to keep winning to make the MW title gm. USU's offense is putting up 472 ypg/34 ppg vs MW foes but WY does have a pretty solid defense as they give up just 328 ypg/20 ppg to MW foes. WY has ran for 224 ypg (4.9) the L/4 gms but face a USU run D that has given up just 66 rush ypg (1.7) the L/4 gms! USU's D struggled early on (446 ypg/29 ppg) but over the L/2 gms are all'g just 286 ypg/20 ppg & on the road WY's offense gets held to 51 ypg less than what their foes allow. Against MW foes TY USU is +77 ypg/+6 ppg while WY is -4 ypg/-7 ppg. USU is on a 4-0 ATS run & we look for that streak to continue.

Colorado St by 3 over HAWAII - Hawaii has covered the L/3 gms in this series. CSU started MW play 2-0 SU/ATS but are now are on a 4 gm SU/ATS losing streak incl a 35-21 loss to AF LW (3★ LP winner!). UH has dropped 3 straight gms as they have only avg'd 287 ypg/18 ppg, but CSU's D has given up 472 ypg/31 ppg the L/3 gms. Hawaii's D over the L/6 gms is allowing 454 ypg/31 ppg. CSU does rely on their rush attack (163, 3.8 vs MW foes) and Hawaii just all'd 293 rush yds (6.0) to UNLV last wk. UH's OL has all'd 32 sks this ssn incl 12 sks the L/3 gms & CSU's pass rush has 33 sks on the year. We see CSU as the slightly better team & will take them by a FG.

Buffalo at BALL ST - Ball St 8-2 SU & 6-4 ATS in series. This is a rematch of the 2020 MAC Championship game, when Ball St won 38-28 as a 13 pt dog, to win their first MAC Title since 1996. How things have changed in a year as both are out of their divisional races & fighting just to become bowl eligible. Will one of these be our Tuesday Night Marquee winner?

Western Michigan at NORTHERN ILLINOIS - If the Huskies are off a win over Buffalo, this game is meaningless & they have the MAC Championship on deck. If they lost that game, then this game will decide who will win the MAC West Title. 4★ New Orleans over PHILADELPHIA - After a surprising 30-13 win in "Mile High" where they finished with a 386-309 yd edge, PHI returns home where they are 0-4 for the 1st time since '13. The Saints meanwhile fell just short of a comeback attempt in Nashville (missed 2 pt conv w/1:16 left in 2 pt defeat, NO 373-264 yd edge). In the Saints' late ssn trip to PHI LY, the Eagles jumped out to a 17-0 HT lead in the eventual 3 pt win (413-358 yd edge). With PHI on just a 10-16 overall ATS run coming in and NO covering 8 of their L/11 away from the Superdome, we have no issue giving the visitor the TD lean.

FORECAST: New Orleans by 7

3★ Green Bay over MINNESOTA - This marks the only HG in a 5-week span for the Vikings as they return to MIN following a 3 pt OT loss to BAL and a 27-20 win in LA against the Chargers (381-253 yd edge). The Packers have also been road warriors of late as this is their 3rd AG in a 4-week span following a 17-0 win LW in Lambeau against SEA where we picked up a 3★ Newsletter Winner on GB and a 3★ LP Winner on Under 50! In their 2nd meeting a season ago, MIN went into Lambeau and picked up a 28-22 upset victory with Dalvin Cook exploding for 226 total yards and 4 TD's. With the Vikings having failed to cover 6 of their past 8 DIV HG's and the Packers on a 10-4 ATS run against the NFC North, we'll call for them to get some revenge in this one.

FORECAST: Green Bay by 10

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Indianapolis (+) over BUFFALO - The Colts have picked up victories in 4 of their past 5 contests following a 6 pt home win over the Jags where they were surprisingly held to just 15 FD's and 295 yds (4-game streak of 30+ pts snapped). The Bills meanwhile rebounded from an ugly loss in JAX with a 28 pt win at the Jets where QB Josh Allen threw for 366 yds and 2 TD's (BUF 489-366 yd edge). In their WC Rnd meeting of a season ago, the Bills got a 378 total yard, 3 TD day from Josh Allen in the 3 point victory. While this is BUF's only HG in 4-wk span with a Thanksgiving trip to the Superdome on deck, leaning against a Colts team that's covered 7 of their past 9 AG's could be risky.

OTHER PLAYS

New England at ATLANTA - Thursday - Rematch of SB LI, a game that saw the Patriots storm back from a 28-3 deficit in the 3Q to eventually win in OT. That win by NE was their 6th straight in the series (SU & ATS). The Falcons are at home for the only time in a 4-week span following an upset of the Saints in the Superdome and a 43-3 blowout loss to the Cowboys where they were held to just 11 FD's and 214 yds. The Patriots meanwhile were on the positive side of a blowout over the Browns where they finished with 30-17 FD and 452-217 yd edges in a 45-7 victory. While the Patriots were an impressive 19-9 ATS against the NFC from '13-'19, the past 2 years has seen them fail to cover 5 of 8 non-conf matchups. The Falcons on the other hand have gone from a porous 1-11 ATS run against the AFC from '17-'19 to a 5-1 ATS mark in those contests the past 2 years. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

CLEVELAND by 6 over Detroit - Following an embarrassing road loss in Foxboro to the Patriots where they were held to just 7 pts and 217 yds, the Browns are back at home for the only time in a 4-week span to take on a Lions squad that finished in a 16-16 tie LW on the road against the Steelers where they had a ssn-high 229 rush yds (3★ LP Winner on Under 40.5!). The Browns have dropped 4 straight matchups against the Lions (1-3 ATS) including a 14 point defeat in '17 where they actually had FD (26-16) and yard (413-345) edges. While CLE shouldn't overlook any opponent considering that they're sitting at just 5-5 on the year, they do have a key trip to BAL on deck. With DET covering 8 of their L/11 as a NDIV AD coming in, we'll call for them to stay within a TD.

San Francisco by 8 over JACKSONVILLE - After a shocking 9-6 upset win over the Bills (+14) two weeks ago at home, the Jags were unable to grab another win LW in IND despite a late comeback attempt (trailed by 3 in the 4Q) and a 331-295 yd edge. The 49ers meanwhile head to the East Coast on short rest after a MNF meeting with the Rams. The 49ers have picked up 3 consecutive wins and covers against the Jaguars (20 pt avg MOV) including a 44-33 shootout victory in '17 (JAX 32-26 FD & 472-369 yd edges). They have also gone 13-6 ATS as a NDIV AF while covering 11 of their L/17 against the AFC. With JAX a disastrous 8-31 ATS against the NFC and failing to cover 8 of their past 10 as a NDIV HD, the visitor gets the edge in this one.

Miami by 6 over NY JETS - Following a 28 pt loss to the Bills where QB Mike White was forced into 4 int's (BUF 489-366 yd edge), the Jets are back at home for a 2nd consecutive week to take on a MIA squad with extra rest after a Thur night meeting with the Ravens. That BAL matchup went much better than expected with QB Tagovailoa coming off the bench in the 2H leading MIA to a pair of TD's in a 22-10 win. The Dolphins have picked up wins in 6 of their L/7 against the Jets (6-0-1 ATS) including a 2-game sweep in '20 where they outscored them by a 44-3 margin. With the Jets also failing to cover 17 of their past 22 DIV contests and MIA covering 5 of their past 7 AFC East AG's, the visitor gets the lean here.

CAROLINA by 7 over Washington - The return of HC Ron Rivera who held the same position with the Panthers from '11-'19. WAS ended a 4-game losing skid LW at home in shocking fashion by knocking off the favored Bucs by a 29-19 score (WAS 23-14 FD & 320-273 yd edges). The Panthers also rebounded in surprising fashion LW in the desert against the Cardinals (2★ Newsletter Winner!) in the return of Cam Newton finishing with 24-11 FD and 341-169 yd edges in a 24 pt victory. In the Panthers' late season trip to WAS a year ago, they would jump out to a 20 pt lead in the 2Q before having to hold on late in the 7 point win (WAS 386-280 yd edge). While CAR is just 1-6 ATS as a HF coming in, WAS has failed to cover 7 of their L/9 overall (WAS 1-5 ATS as a dog).

Baltimore by 3 over CHICAGO - Following an unexpected 12 pt loss in South Beach against the Dolphins last Thur where they were held without a TD until late in the 4Q, the Ravens head into the "Windy City" to take on a well-rested Bears squad that returns to action after their week off (CHI 0-7 ATS after a bye). The Bears have gotten OT wins over the Ravens in each of their past 2 matchups including '17 where they had a 342-291 yard edge. With BAL just 9-18 ATS as a NDIV AF and CHI showing some fight 2 weeks ago in their narrow (and controversial) loss on MNF to PIT, we like the home squad to stay within the line here.

TENNESSEE by 14 over Houston - The Titans have been on quite the run in recent weeks following their 6th consecutive win LW at home against the Saints (TEN overFD'd 22-17 & out-gained 373-264 in 2 pt win). The Texans meanwhile return from their bye week with just a 3-7 ATS mark as a DIV AD. The Titans have come out victorious in each of their past 3 meetings with the Texans putting up an average of 39 ppg and 520 ypg in that span. With TEN posting a solid 7-2 ATS run and covering 5 of their L/6 inside of the AFC South, a 2 TD lean seems about right.

LAS VEGAS by 3 over Cincinnati - The Bengals return from their bye week on a little bit of a slide following a surprising road loss to the Jets and an embarrassing home defeat against DIV rival CLE. The Raiders meanwhile were blasted at home against the Chiefs who finished with 29-15 FD and 516-299 yd edges. The Raiders ended a 3-game losing skid in their last meeting against the Bengals ('19) finishing with a 386-246 yard edge. With CIN failing to cover 5 straight following their bye and the Raiders needing a win here to stay in contention inside of the AFC West, we'll go ahead and give the home team a FG lean in this one.

Arizona by 5 over SEATTLE - The Seahawks return home after being shutout for the 1st time since 2011 LW in Lambeau Field against the Packers (QB Wilson 20-40-161-0-2 in return from inj). The Cardinals meanwhile suffered just their 2nd defeat of the ssn LW at home against the Panthers (2★ LP Winner on CAR) with QB Kyle Murray and WR DeAndre Hopkins each missing their 2nd consecutive games (CAR 24-11 FD & 341-169 yd edge). In the Cardinals' Thur night trip to the Pacific NW a year ago, the Seahawks (-3) finished with a 347-314 yard edge in the 28-21 victory. While SEA has gone an impressive 7-3 ATS as a HF coming in, the Cardinals (CS on Murray & Hopkins) can go all out here with a week off on deck (ARZ 5-2-1 ATS before a bye).

Dallas by 3 over KANSAS CITY - The Chiefs are back inside of Arrowhead for the 3rd time in 4 wks following a blowout win over the Raiders where QB Patrick Mahomes threw for 406 yds and 5 TD's. The Cowboys meanwhile got back on track LW against the Falcons in easy fashion (22-11 FD & 431-214 yd edges in a 40 pt victory). In their most recent meeting in '17 the Cowboys (-2) picked up a 28-17 home victory finishing with 24-17 FD and 375-323 yard edges. With DAL covering 8 of their 9 contests on the year including all 4 AG's, we'll go ahead and call for them to get the outright win in this one as KC has failed to cover 15 of their L/18 games overall including an 0-9 ATS run at home!

Pittsburgh at LA CHARGERS - SNF - The Steelers head out West following a 2-game home-stand that saw them escape on MNF against the Bears and tie against the winless Lions with QB Ben Roethlisberger out with Covid (bkp Rudolph 30-50-242-1-1). The Chargers meanwhile couldn't get the job done LW at home against the Vikings who held LAC to 132 yds under their season avg. The Steelers have won 10 of their L/13 matchups against the Chargers including a 24-17 road win in '19 (led 24-0 early 3Q, LAC 248-256 yd edge). While PIT is an impressive 13-4 ATS as an AD, the Chargers are on an 8-4-1 spread run coming in. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Ny Giants at TAMPA BAY - MNF - The Bucs return home following yet another rough road outing in WAS where they suffered their 3rd loss of the season (0-5 ATS away from Tampa TY). The Giants meanwhile are well-rested after their bye week having posted ATS wins in 19 of their L/24 contests when listed as an AD. In the Bucs' MNF trip to NY a year ago, the Giants (+12) got a TD w/19 left but missed the 2 point conversion in the 25-23 loss (TB won for just the 2nd time in L/9 tries vs NYG). While an outright win by the Bucs is more than likely in this one, keep in mind that they've gone just 6-14-2 ATS as a NDIV HF.
