Eastern Michigan +8 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over Eastern Michigan (Friday)- Both are 7-4 and should each have a bowl game on deck but the Winner takes home the Michigan MAC Trophy as both have wins over WM (CM 42-30 & EM 22-21) EM is just 2-7 SU & ATS vs CM including a 31-23 loss LY as a 6' pt HD. Visitor is just 1-5 SU but 3-3 ATS. Against 6 common foes both are 3-3 ATS. CM is 4-2 SU outgaining foes 447-421 while EM is 3-3 SU being outgained 466-298. While both allowed an avg 27 ppg in those games, CM avg 32 ppg compared to EM's 30, a diff of just 2 but CM has opened over a td favorite. The Eagles are also 13-4 ATS when a dog of less than 14 and impressively have won 9 of those games outright so we will take the Eagles & the points knowing this could be win 10.

Louisiana Tech by 1 over RICE - LT has won 6 straight series mtgs but Rice has covered the L/2. LT was -15' at home LW, ply'g a SMiss team who was 0-9 SU vs FBS foes yet the Bulldogs lost 35-19. Despite SMiss not even using an actual QB (ply'd RB's as QB's due to inj's), LT was actually out-passed 110-100 and QB Allen threw 2 int's including a pick 6 late that ruined a great call for our Friday Night Marquee. Rice led UTEP 21-14 LW at half but didn't score again until 5:42 left, losing 38-28 (+9). Rice is 3-0 ATS in ssn finales under Bloomgren and LT is ply'g with a 3rd string QB. Rice is 2-9 ATS but LT is 1-5 ATS as favorites this year so neither side is very appealing.

Utah by 7 over NORTH TEXAS - The home tm is 6-1 SU/7-0 ATS in this series. LY UTSA led 49-10 and NT scored in 6bg time. NT has been a different team ever since they were embarrassed by Marshall. The Mean Green have won 4 straight (5-0 ATS run) including LW when we used NT as a 2★ in these pages then upgraded to a 3★ LP as they crushed FIU 49-7 (-10'), putting up a ssn high 611 yds. UTSA is ply'g with unbeaten pressure and have failed to cover their L/2. LW they were -4 vs UAB and trailed until the gms final play when QB Harris made a desperation heave into the EZ. NT needs a win to get bowl elig so we think the Mean Green keep this within a td.

ARIZONA ST by 24 over Arizona - After a rough outing LW in Pullman where they were outgd' 482-369 in a 26 pt defeat, the Wildcats head to Tempe to take on a Sun Devils squad that was shut down LW in Corvallis against the Beavers who finished with a 327-266 yd edge in a 24-10 victory. In their matchup of a year ago, the Sun Devils (-11') went into Tucson and picked up a 70-7 win (largest MOV in series history) thanks in part to a +7 TO edge (ASU 486-350 yd edge). With the Sun Devils having now won 4 straight in the series (best stretch s/75-78) and the Wildcats being held to just 17.4 ppg on the ssn (#121 in FBS), it wouldn't surprise us to see another convincing win by the home tm here.

OLD DOMINION by 14 over Charlotte - Both tms need a win to get bowl eligible but ODU is clearly playing better having won 4 straight including LW at Middle Tenn 24-17. The Monarchs have a huge edge on D, allowing 363 ypg and holding foes 49 ypg below their avg while UC allows 467 ypg and 101 ypg more than their foes avg. UC only trailed 21-14 at half LW vs Marshall but was outscored 21-0 in 3Q of 49-28 (+14') loss. Against 6 common foes UC is 2-4 SU/2-3-1 ATS. -13 ppg/-85 ypg while ODU is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS. +3 ppg/+4 ypg. HC Rahne should get some CUSA COY votes for the job he's done and we will gladly take the team on a 4 game win streak with a huge defensive edge.

APPALACHIAN ST by 28 over Georgia Southern - These former FCS conf rivals are now SBC rivals and LY App St snapped a 2 gm losing skid to GSthrn but the Eagles have covered 3 straight. App St has the SBC title on deck while GSthrn is going through a rough 3-8 ssn. App St's offense has ran for 221 ypg (4.8) the L/4 gms while GSthrn is all'g 183 rush ypg the L/4 gms. GSthrn struggles vs the pass (#121 pass D) all'g 293 ypg (63%) App St's is avg'g 252 pass ypg (65%). The L/4 gms App St is all'g just 254 ypg & they are +185 ypg/+32 ppg while GSthrn -37 ypg/-9 ppg. Overall vs common foes App St is +120 ypg/+17 ppg & GSthrn is -51 ypg/-10 ppg. We see App St having little trouble in this gm & we'll call for them by 4 td's.

Byu by 9 over USC - Following a 62-33 defeat against the Bruins in QB Dart's 1st start (27-47-325-1-2), the Trojans are back at home for a 2nd consecutive week to take on a BYU squad that moved to 9-2 on the year LW on the road against Ga Southern with 26-19 FD and 507-268 yd edges. The Cougars and Trojans have met on 3 other occasions (USC 2-1 SU edge) with their most recent contest coming back in '19. In their early ssn trip to Provo, the Trojans (-4) kicked a 52-yd FG to force OT. An int in OT (3rd of the gm) would eventually spell doom for USC in the 30-27 loss. While the Trojans are clearly seeking revenge from that defeat, this road-tested a tough BYU squad that already has 4 wins over the P12 this year should be able to get the job done in this one.

UCLA by 3 over California - After an unplanned week off due to Covid the week prior against USC, the Bears returned to action a week ago in the "Big Game" against Stanford and dominated with a 636-282 yd edge in a 41-11 win. The Bruins meanwhile also took part in their biggest rivalry LW as they picked up an easy 29 pt win inside of the Coliseum against the Trojans (ssn-high 609 yds). In their matchup inside of the Rose Bowl a ssn ago, the Bruins (+3') picked up a 6th win in the last 8 tries by outgaining Cal 440-176 in a 34-10 victory. While we have no problem calling for the Bruins to pick up another victory against the Bears in this one, a 3-10 ATS run as home chalk for UCLA and a 13-1 ATS mark for Cal as an AD has us cutting this line off at just a fg.

OREGON by 4 over Oregon St - Following a big 24-10 home win over the Sun Devils where they held ASU to a ssn-low 266 yds (avg 423 ypg coming in), the Beavers head 50 miles South to Eugene looking to hand the Ducks their 2nd consecutive defeat. Oregon did see their Playoff bubble burst LW in SLC against the Utes who held them to just 7 pts and 294 yds in a 31 pt defeat. While the Ducks have won 11 of the past 13 meetings in the Civil War (incl L/6 in Autzen Stadium), the Beavers did pick up a surprising 41-38 (+13) upset against #9 UO LY in Corvallis (GW 1-yd TD run on 4th&g w/33 left). With the Beavers having covered 10 of their past 11 as an AD dating back to '19, we'll call for them to stay within a td in this one.

WYOMING by 14 over Hawaii - These tms have split SU wins in the L/5 gms & the home is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS as MW foes. WY is off an shocking 44-17 win where they put up 604 yds while UH is one win away from a bowl. UH's defense has all'd 465+ yds in 6 of their L/7 gms incl 651 yds LW to Colo St incl 527 pass yds! UH's run D has all'd 176 ypg (3.8) the L/4 gms but WY has picked up their rush attack the L/4 gms (288, 6.0) and they even threw for 242 yds LW. UH's offense put up 535 yds LW but face a WY D that is all'g just 333 ypg vs MW foes. Against common MW foes WY is +94 ypg/+5 ppg while UH is -100 ypg/-4 ppg. UH is just 1-5 ATS on the road TY and with weather/wind possibly being a factor here we see WY winning by 2 TD's.

OKLAHOMA ST by 3 over Oklahoma - 116th mtg of Bedlam! OU has won 6 straight (5-1 ATS) mtgs. The winner of this gm reaches the B12 title gm. OSU is off a 23-0 win vs TTech (3★ newsletter winner upgraded to a 4★ LP winner!) and comes in with our #1 ranked D and they are all'g just 243 ypg/13 ppg vs B12 foes and are holding B12 foes 175 ypg under their ssn avg. They face an OU offense led by QB Williams & they are avg'g 425 ypg/36 ppg vs B12 foes. OSU's offense has improved as the ssn has gone on & over the L/4 wks are avg'g 493 ypg/41 ppg (+313 ypg/+36 ppg L/4 gms) but OU is all'g 390 ypg the L/4 gms. Against common foes OSU is +205 ypg/+21 ppg while OU is +18 ypg/+9 ppg. While the numbers seem to point to a larger win for OSU (OSU 9-0 ATS run), this is a rivalry game & we'll call for the home tm to squeak out a win by a FG.

SERIES PLAY OF THE WEEK.....ULM

SMU by 7 over Tulsa - The Golden Hurricane have won 5 of the L7 w/ one outright upset and have covered 4 straight. LTH ('19), Tulsa held a 14-pt HT lead but fell in 3OT, 43-37 (+13). The 'Canes are 9-1 ATS as AD the L3Y and playing to become bowl eligible w/ a victory. Tulsa is fresh off a tune-up at home courtesy of Temple (-22), 44-10, where they held a 513-293 yd edge. SMU was outgained 73-290 in the 1H at Cincinnati LW (+10), and were sent back to Dallas w/ their most lopsided loss S/16 (48-14). We think Tulsa falls short by a TD.

Alabama by 10 over AUBURN - Auburn has actually won the last 2 Iron Bowl's they've hosted, though they were only +3 and +5 in those and this time they are getting xx pts after losing 21-17 (-7') at SCar last week. QB Finley made his first start at Auburn and hit 17-32-188-1-0. QB Young set a school record with 559 yds last week but Bama only won 42-35 (-20'), allowing Ark to put up 468 yds. Aub's OL has allowed just 16 sacks but will have their hands full with LB Will Anderson who #2 in the nation with 13 sacks. Bama has struggles on the road, only beating FL by 2, losing at A&M and yds were even with Miss St at half. Against 5 common foes, Aub is +1 ppg/-21 ypg while Bama is +14 ppg/+152 ypg. This is just their 4th true road game all ssn and Aub is +121 ypg at home. We think Bama's road struggles crop up again and Auburn keeps it within 2 td's.

MEMPHIS by 15 over Tulane - UM is on a 2-6 SU/ATS backslide after beginning the yr 3-0 w/ an outright upset of Miss St. The Tigers have made 7 straight bowl gms and all they must do to secure an 8th is beat Tulane who just snapped their 9-gm losing streak LW vs fellow last place USF. The Wave can't stop WR Calvin Austin, who is #12 in FBS w/ 1129 yds and is a cut above everyone on this field w/ his top-end speed. Memphis' D also has talent like LB JJ Russell, who is 6th in FBS in tackles (113). Tulane's happy to see their tragic ssn both on and off the field come to an end and pack it in here.

Clemson by 7 over SOUTH CAROLINA - Clemson has won 6 straight in this series (4-2 ATS) but the series was disrupted LY due to Covid. SC is bowl eligible after beating Auburn 21-17. Clem comes in off their best performance on offense this ssn, putting up a ssn high 543 yds in their 48-27 (-4) win over WF. SC's D will be a much stiffer test, holding foes to 356 ypg and 38 ypg below their avg. Clem relied on their run game LW, putting up 333 (6.2) but SC only allows 133 (4.1) rush at home. SC has ply'd the tougher sked (#39 vs #63). Clem is -110 ypg and 1-3 ATS on the road while SC is +73 ypg at home and beat both FL and Auburn as home dogs so our lean is with the underdog Gamecocks.

Penn St by 3 over MICHIGAN ST - Michigan St defied every expectation coming into this ssn after finishing 2-5 SU/2-4-1 ATS LY, but that does not excuse what took place LW in Columbus. Sparty was utterly humiliated by the Buckeyes on the road (+19'), 56-7, costing themselves a potential B10 East title and a playoff spot while squandering Kenneth Walker's Heisman hopes. This type of loss strips tms of their confidence and identity, and Penn St is fresh off a shutout win at home over Rutgers (-17), 28-0, doing so w/o QB Clifford for a majority of the gm. Backup QB Veilleux was impressive LW (235, 63%, 3/0), so regardless of who is under center, the Nittany Lions should have no problem moving the ball against a pass D all'g 340 ypg through the air (dead last in FBS). We like Penn St by a FG.

Florida St by 3 over FLORIDA - Two rivals going in opposite directions. FSU started 0-4 including a loss to FCS Jacksonville St but has won 5 of their L7 including upset wins over NCar and Miami. FL started 3-1 with a 2 pt loss vs Bama but has lost 5 of their L7 including upset losses at LSU, SC & MO while they struggled against Samford, allowing 52 pts and 530 yds in an 18 pt win. FL fired Dan Mullen after LW's 24-23 OT loss at Mizouu. The Gators had a 360-286 yd edge. FSU has led their L/2 gms 20-0 2Q vs Miami & 26-3 3Q at BC but barely won both. QB Travis threw for 3 td's and has a 14-5 ratio, along with 428 rush (3.7). Going against the 'Noles has burned us the last 2 weeks and FL is a mess so we will call for FSU to pull the outright upset.

Texas A&M by 10 over LSU - LY A&M led 20-0 but LSU scored with :38 for a backdoor cover. The Aggies are fresh off a beatdown of Prairie View A&M 52-3. LSU only beat ULM 27-14 (-29) and the Tigers even got two SOD at the LSU2. A&M is +80 ypg and their D is holding foes 71 ypg below their avg. LSU is -9 ypg but have ply'd the tougher sked (#9 vs #50) and LB Damone Clark leads the SEC with 126 tkl's. LSU was already banged up and announced LW 2 starting OL are OFY, which isn't good when facing A&M's DE's Johnson & Leal who combine for 16 sacks! A win makes LSU bowl eligible but we think A&M makes this Orgeron's last game and A&M is on a 5-1 ATS run and Fisher is 7-1 as an AF.

LOUISIANA by 14 over ULM - 56th Battle of the Bayou. LA has won 6 of the L7 mtgs SU but the home tm is a shocking 1-16-1 ATS in the L/18 mtgs! LA has their spot in the SBC title gm locked up & have won 10 straight gms SU & have covered 4 of their L/6 gms while ULM is 4-7 SU but have covered 4 times as DD dogs incl 3 outright upsets. LA is holding foes to 56 ypg under their ssn avg and ULM is avg'g 372 ypg/24 ppg on offense. LA avg's 219 rush ypg (5.4) vs SBC foes but ULM has all'd under 100 rush yds the L/2 gms. Against common foes LA is +83 ypg/+17 ppg while ULM is -68 ypg/-7 ppg. While we see LA getting the win, they have a much bigger game on deck & could rest str's if up big in 2H.

ARKANSAS ST by 3 over Texas St - Ark St is 6-2 SU vs TXSt as SBC foes but lost LY on the road 47-45. Ark St's D has struggled TY (495 ypg/39 ppg all'd vs SBC foes) but 2 wks ago their offense put up 538 yds vs ULM & here they face a TXSt D that allows 45 ypg above what their SBC foes typically allow. Against common SBC foes Ark St is -125 ypg/-14 ppg while TXSt is -84 ypg/-12 ppg. TXSt hasn't won a SBC road gm since 2018 & we see Ark St getting the win by a FG.

FAU by 3 over Middle Tennessee - The home team is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series including LTH when FAU won 28-13 (-11') as our 5★ Oct GOM in '19. QB Vattiato threw for 281 LW but MT lost 24-17 (-3') at home vs ODU. FAU enters off a 52-17 (+10) loss at WKU. The winner of this game is bowl eligible. FAU is 4-1 SU and +149 ypg at home while MT is 1-5 SU/1-4-1 ATS and -60 ypg on the road. FAU has the edge on offense while MT has edges on D & ST's but we like the home Owls to win by a fg.

Nevada by 9 over COLORADO ST - Nev has won 2 of the L/3 mtgs and have covered 3 straight against CSU. The Rams can't reach a bowl while Nev is 7-4 but out of the MW title race after losing their L/2 gms by a comb'd 4 pts. After starting the year with a strong D, CSU is all'g 488 ypg/36 ppg the L/4 gms incl over 500 yds all'd the L/2 gms. Last wk CSU all'd 406 pass yds to Haw and now face a Nev pass attack avg'g 367 ypg (69%) vs MW foes. The Nev D has all'd 401 ypg/27 ppg the L/4 gms incl 499 yds LW and here face a CSU offense that put up 651 yds LW. We see CSU's D as a big issue and Nev is 4-1 ATS in their L/5 gms following a SU loss. We see Nev winning here by over a TD.
