SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - MERCEDEZ-BENZ STADIUM - ATLANTA, GA

4★ Alabama over Florida - This is the 10th time these 2 have met in the SEC Title game with Bama winning 5 times (4-4-1 ATS). Bama is 8-4 SU/5-6-1 ATS in the SEC Title game and have won each of their last 6 trips by 18 ppg. UF is 7-5 SU/7-4-1 ATS but they've lost the last 3 by 24 ppg, all against Bama and their last win was back in Nick Saban's 1st trip here. The Crimson Tide enter after crushing Ark 52-3 (-31). The Tide avg 538 ypg and they've put up the most yds that 5 of their foes have all'd, avg 145 ypg more than their foes allow. UF is coming off a shocking 37-34 (-23) loss vs LSU. The Gators held a 609-418 yd edge but were -3 TO's and a boneheaded penalty all'd LSU to extend their go ahead drive. UF avg 514 ypg and 100 ypg more than their foes allow. Both teams have explosive passing games led by Heisman candidate but Bama clearly has the edge on DEF, holding foes 70 ypg below their avg and they've allowed just 8.8 ppg & 261 ypg in their L/6. The Tide are #7 in our pass D rankings while UF is only #72. Against 8 common foes, Bama is 8-0 SU/6-2 ATS, +32.6 ppg & +198 ypg while UF is 6-2 SU/4-3-1 ATS, +14.3 ppg & +136 ypg. Bama has dominated in this game of late, have covered 7 straight this ssn and we call for the Tide to win by more than 3 touchdowns.

FORECAST: Alabama by 24

AAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - NIPPERT STADIUM - CINCINNATI, OH

3★ Tulsa (+) over Cincinnati - Teams were supposed to play last week but it was canceled due to covid issues at Cincy, so they are the host. Cincy has not played since their Nov 21st win at UCF while Tulsa's last game was 2 wks ago & they won 19-6 at Navy. It will be a battle of strong DEF's as Tulsa comes in all'g just 337 ypg vs AAC foes & are holding AAC foes to 92 ypg under their ssn avg while Cincy's DEF is all'g 306 ypg vs AAC foes & are holding AAC foes to 168 ypg under their ssn avg! Cincy's OFF does have the edge over Tulsa led by QB Ridder (1821, 67%, 16-6, 526 rush, 7.9, 11 td) as they have put up 540 ypg & 45 ppg in their L/4, but before the Navy gm Tulsa was avg'g 461 yds/34 pts vs AAC foes & they got QB Smith back 2 wks ago. Against 4 common AAC foes Cincy is +168 ypg/+23 ppg while Tulsa is +54 ypg/+11 ppg, but Cincy had not played in nearly a month & could come out rusty. We like Tulsa to keep this game close as they are 5-1 ATS the L2Y as an AAC underdog incl pulling an outright upset of UCF on the road this season.

FORECAST: Cincinnati by 6

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Ole Miss over LSU - HC Orgeron has won all 4 mtgs vs the school that fired him and the Tigers had covered 3 straight before LY when they failed to cover by a half point in a 58-37 win. LSU has won the L/4 mtgs by 20.8 ppg but the Tigers are coming off a huge emotional win after beating Florida on a 57 yd fg. LSU was outgained 609-418 but were +3 TO's and probably wouldn't have won if it weren't for the infamous shoe throw. UM got a week off after their game vs A&M was postponed early in the week. The Rebels are on a 3 game winning streak and are +35 ypg this ssn while LSU is -68 ypg. LSU allows 331 pass ypg and their defense allows 84 ypg more than their foes avg. UM is putting up 357 pass ypg and their offense avg 170 ypg more than their foes allow. HC Kiffin will be hungry to beat his former asst who replaced him as Interim HC after he was fired at USC. Against 7 common foes, LSU is 4-3 SU/ATS, -2.5 ppg & -73 ypg. UM is 3-4 SU/ATS, +2.3 ppg & +54 ypg. Both defenses are leaky but Ole Miss has the edge on offense and with the Tigers coming off an emotional upset win so we will call for the Rebels to pull the upset. **FORECAST: Ole Miss by 7**

2★ Iowa over Michigan - Last year both teams finished w/ssn low yds as Mich won 10-3 (-3). The Hawkeyes enter on a 6 game winning streak after LW's 28-7 (+2) win over Wisconsin. Iowa had a +113 yd edge and never trailed. Mich avoided an inevitable beatdown when they had to cancel 'The Game' vs Ohio St due to their own Covid issues. Mich has lost 4 of their last 5 games and their only win came in OT over Rutgers. The Wolverines are -53 ypg and they are allowing 76 ypg more than their foes avg. Iowa is just 2 plays away from being undefeated (2 losses by combined 5 pts) and are +55 ypg. The Hawkeyes are holding foes 69 ypg below their avg. Mich lost to that same Wisc team 49-11 and was outgained by 249 yds. We can't see any reason to back the Wolverines here. Iowa is one of the hottest teams in the country and 5 of their 6 wins are by 20 pts or more while Mich has failed to cover 5 straight.

FORECAST: Iowa by 21

OTHER GAMES

FRIDAY DECEMBER 18TH

Nebraska by 1 over RUTGERS - Neb is 4-0 SU all-time in this series with 3 wins coming in Big 10 play, all by 10 pts or more. Rut is coming off their 3rd upset win of the ssn, beating MD 27-24 (+6). Neb was upset as nearly DD chalk LW at home vs Minn who was missing nearly 36 players due to Covid. The Huskers avg 367 ypg and are -42 ypg for the ssn. Their offense avg 4 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. Rut avg 346 ypg and is -78 ypg on the season. Their offense avg 51 ypg less than their foes allow. The Scarlet Knights are 5-2 as dogs under Schiano while HC Frost just 4-11 as chalk. We'd much rather take the points here and call for Neb to only win by less than a fg.

CUSA TITLE GAME - JOAN C. EDWARDS STADIUM - HUNTINGTON, WV

Uab by 1 over MARSHALL - MU is 8-2 SU all-time vs UAB including 5-0 in Joan C. Edwards Stadium but they haven't met since 2013. MU is 1-1 SU/0-2 in CUSA Title gms back in '13 & '14. UAB is ply'g in the CUSA Title gm for the 3rd straight year. They were blown out by FAU 49-6 LY but did win in '18. LW the Blazers ply'd for the first time since 10/31 & beat Rice, who beat MU the previous week 20-0 despite the Owls not having their starting QB. UAB trailed 13-7 at half but did hold a 354-254 yd edge and the Blazers were missing a dozen key players including their top 2 RB's (contact tracing) and WR Austin Watkins (opted out prior to gm). MU had their gm vs Charlotte cancelled. UAB is +74 ypg and +110 vs CUSA foes. MU is +171 ypg but only +117 vs CUSA foes. UAB only allows 54% completions and they have our #16 ranked pass D. Herd QB Wells is hitting 63% w/a 16-9 ratio but he's coming off his worst performance of the season, throwing 5 int's vs Rice 2 weeks ago. MU is traditionally tough to beat at home but they've lost 10 home games in the last 5 years and if UAB gets some of their depleted roster back (only 43 scholarship ply'rs available LW) then they could easily pull the upset and HC Holiday is only 7-16 as a HF.

MAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - FORD FIELD - DETROIT, MI

Buffalo by 9 over Ball St - Buffalo makes their 3rd trip to the MAC title game, while Ball St makes their 2nd. These tms met in the MAC title game in '08 when Ball St came in 12-0 (Ranked #12 in BCS, 15' pt chalk) but fumbled 4 times (2 ret'd for TD) and UB pulled the upset 42-24. UB comes in 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS record while Ball St's "Detroit or bust!" mission is complete after winning their L/5 games incl a comeback 30-27 win last week vs WMich (3★ LP Winner on Ball St!). UB is led by RB Patterson who ran for 1,025 yds (8.3, 18 td!) in just 5 gms! As a team UB ran for 345 ypg (7.5) and QB Vantrese threw just 85 passes (821, 60%, 6-1) in 5 gms but UB all'd ZERO sks! They face a solid Ball St DEF that has all'd just 148 ypg (3.9) and overall Ball St's DEF is allowing 432 ypg & are giving up 16 ypg more than their foes avg. Ball St has gotten good play from QB Plitt (1674, 66%,

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13-5) but will be without star RB Huntley (437, 5.5, 6 td) who opted out after missing the L/3 gms with an inj. UB's DEF has all'd 367 ypg on the season but Ball St has played the tougher schedule. While losing Huntley is a big loss for Ball St, the Cardinals are 4-1 ATS the L2Y as a MAC dog & we think they can stay within single digits against a strong UB team.

PAC 12 TITLE GAME - LA MEMORIAL COLISEUM - LOS ANGELES, CA

USC by 4 over Oregon - Washington was scheduled to play in this game but they were forced to withdrawal due to CoVid issues (had below the PAC 12 minimum of available scholarship players). Oregon was originally supposed to play in this stadium against Colorado on Saturday but are much happier to play in the Title game with a chance to defend their P12 Crown. These teams met here last year in the regular ssn. Oregon trailed 10-0 after 1Q but led 28-17 at HT & won easily 56-24 as a 4 pt AF. Ducks only had a 405-355 yd edge as but were +3 TO (incl a 32 yd IR td) & also had a KR td w/08 left in 2Q. LW we won our 4★ top LPS last week (now 13-2, 87% on the season!!!) on USC in their 43-38 (-3) win over UCLA. That was their 5th win & third straight cover. Oregon had their gm vs UW canceled LW. They had opened the ssn 3-0 but in their last 2 suffered upset losses losing to rival Oregon St 41-38 as a 13 pt AD & California 21-17 as a 9 pt AD. USC is just 7-11 as a HF. We expect USC to pull out another close win here.

SATURDAY DECEMBER 19TH

WAKE FOREST by 10 over Florida St - The 'Noles travel to WF for the 2nd straight ssn. FSU had won 7 straight meetings until LY's 22-20 (+2) loss. Last week WF failed to force a TO for the first time all season and lost 45-21 (+2). WF did lead 7-0 into the 2Q and only trailed 28-21 4Q before allowing 17 late points, including 10 that came on short drives. FSU crushed a reeling Duke squad 56-35. The 'Noles led 28-0 1Q and Duke's final td came in garbage time. FSU went back to QB Travis who threw for 192 & rushed for 90 yds. WF avg 13 ypg more than their foes allow while FSU allows 49 ypg more than their foes avg. The Noles are -141 ypg on the road and all 4 road games resulted in losses by 16 pts or more (avg loss by 26.5 ppg). WF is -85 ypg at home but did beat both UVA & VT in Winston-Salem and kept it closer than expected vs Clem. The 'Noles have had too many opt-outs for us to trust them and WF has covered 5 straight at home.

Air Force by 4 over ARMY - 54th meeting, this mtg determines the winner of the C-in-C trophy. Air Force leads the series 36-16-1 SU & since '97 AF is 19-4 SU/16-6-1 ATS. LY AF (-16.5) snapped a 2 gm losing streak to Army, winning 17-13. AF last played on Dec 3rd and despite losing several key players at points during the ssn their rush attack is avg'g 336 yds (5.9) face an Army run D all'g 164 ypg (5.1) the L/4 games. Army is in a unique spot as their last reg ssn game is usually vs Navy but that was last wk & they won 15-0 in a foggy game. Army's rush attack is putting up 280 ypg (4.8) but face an AF run D that is holding foes to 106 ypg (3.6) and held Navy's option to 90 yds. The last 2 mtgs have been decided by just 7 pts so we think this gm will be close, but will slightly lean with AF as the home team is on an 0-5-1 ATS run & AF has the slightly better run D.

WISCONSIN by 17 over Minnesota - The Battle for Paul Bunyan's Axe was scheduled earlier this ssn but ppd due to Covid and was rescheduled here. UW is 15-1 SU but the visitor is 4-2 SU/5-0-1 ATS and the Gophers 1 win was LTH in '18. The Gophers were down nearly 3 dozen players yet pulled out a 24-17 (+9) upset win over Neb which was 1 of 2 upsets on our Big Dog Plays of the week (Just \$9, call 1-800-654-3448). Wisc is coming off 3 straight losses after LW's 28-7 (-2) loss at Iowa. The Badgers are +115 ypg despite being 2-3 while Minn is 3-3, coming off B2B upsets yet are -30 ypg. The Gophers allow 67 ypg more than their foes avg and they've allowed 213 (6.6) rush ypg. Wisc avg 171 rush ypg but the L/3 they've been held under 140. The Badgers DEF only allows 251 ypg and they hold foes 133 ypg below their avg. The Badgers own this series and despite their recent struggles we think they will control the LOS against a weak Minn run D and win by nearly 3 td's.

PENN STATE by 20 over Illinois - PSU has won each of the last 2 meetings by 39 points each. These 2 last met in '18 63-24. Last week we cashed a 4★ Totals play on the Under 41 in ILs 28-10 (+13) loss at NW. The Illini were missing 6 defensive starters and gave up 411 (7.1) rush yds and were outgained by 231 yds! The blowout loss resulted in the firing of Lovie Smith. The Nittany Lions got off to a slow start, trailing Mich St 21-10 at half before rallying to score the last 21 pts & winning 39-24 (-15). PSU is +76 ypg and their defense holds foes 59 ypg below their avg. PSU's run game struggled last week but rushed for 254 & 248 the 2 weeks prior & IL allows 196 (4.8) rush ypg. The Illini allow 77 ypg more than their foes avg. PSU is only 2-7 as a HF but with IL replacing their HC and their defensive starters likely missing this game too, we think PSU will pull out a 20 point win.

Michigan St by 1 over MARYLAND - MD is 0-3 SU but also 3-1 ATS in this series. LY the Terps were more than 3 td dogs but only lost 22-19 in the ssn finale. This gm was scheduled to be ply'd on 11/21 but postponed. The Spartans were +15 and led Penn St 21-10 last week but the Nittany Lions rallied and won by 15. The Spartans offense looks much better under QB Payton Thorne who threw for 325 yds and 3 td's last week. MD announced they were w/o QB Tagovailoa shortly before KO vs Rutgers last week. Rfr QB Legrende started but threw 2 int's and was replaced by Eric Najarian who threw 2 int's but was sk'd 4 times and MD lost 27-24 (-6) in OT. The Spartans are -66 ypg but they've pulled upsets as DD dogs over NW and Mich. MD is -18 ypg and have been upset by Rut & IL. We don't trust either team as chalk and MD could be w/o QB Tagovailoa and their top LB. MSU is 10-3-1 as an AD and we like the job Mel Tucker has done.

UTAH by 14 over Washington St - As Pac-12 foes WSU is 4-3 SU/5-2 ATS. LY Utah (-6) snapped a 4-gm SU/ATS losing streak when they beat WSU 38-13 at home, outgaining them 526-313 (+2 TO's). After losing their F/2 gms this ssn Utah has won 2 in a row incl a 38-21 win at Colorado last wk while WSU has played just 3 gms this ssn & are 1-2 SU. Utah's OFF led by QB Bentley (729, 64%, 5-5) & RB Jordan (443, 7.3) put up 432 yds last wk & face a WSU DEF that all'd over 450 yds to both Oreg & Oreg St. WSU put up 420+ yds in their F/2 gms but only had 263 yds/13 pts at USC 2 wks ago. Utah has another solid defense this ssn as they are all'g 357 ypg & are holding foes to 69 ypg under their ssn avg. We were impressed with Utah last week & the Utes are 9-2 ATS at home vs P12 foes the L3Y while WSU is just 2-5 ATS on the road vs P12 foes the L2Y.

UCLA by 8 over Stanford - From '09-'18 Stanford was 11-0 SU/10-1 ATS against UCLA, but lost LY at home to the Bruins 34-16. Stanford has won their L/3 gms SU/ATS & in 4 gms Stanford QB Mills has thrown for 1,076 yds (65%, 4-0) & overall Stanford is avg'g 387 yds/29 pts over their L/4 gms. They face a UCLA DEF that is holding their foes to 30 ypg under their ssn avg & UCLA comes in with a +160 ypg edge when playing at home. UCLA's OFF has looked explosive this ssn behind QB Thompson-Robinson (1055, 65%, 12-4) who threw for 364 last wk & faces a Stanford pass D ranked #93. UCLA's rush attack is also avg'g 226 yds (4.6) the L/4 gms & the Stanford run D is all'g 208 ypg (5.4) this season. Stanford is just 2-4 ATS the L2Y as a P12 road dog & we'll go with the Bruins here as they have been more impressive of late & have the more explosive OFF.

Arizona St by 7 over OREGON ST - After winning SU/ATS in '17+'18 ASU lost at Oreg St last ssn when they went for 2 after a TD and lost 35-34. ASU only ply'd 3 gms this ssn, but in their last game vs rival they won 70-7 despite only outgaining Ariz by 136 yds (ASU +7 TO's, scored 35 pts off TO's). OSU was one of only two P-12 tms to play all 6 gms (2-4 SU/4-2 ATS). OSU's OFF (398 ypg/28 ppg) is led by RB Jefferson (755, 6.9, 7 td) who ret'd from inj last week but bkp QB Nolan is hitting just 54% (423, 4-1) in his 2 sts. ASU's DEF did allow 161 rush ypg (4.2) but all'd under 365 yds in their L/2 gms. ASU QB Daniels is only hitting 59% (562, 4-1) but they are avg'g 227 yds (5.5) on the ground and face an OSU run DEF that has all'd 191 ypg (4.9) this season. We think ASU uses the momentum from last week's win & closes out the reg ssn with another win.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LUCAS OIL STADIUM - INDIANAPOLIS, IN

† Ohio St by 15 over Northwestern - These two actually met in the Big 10 Title gm just 2 years ago with OSU winning 45-24 (-14'). The Buckeyes did only lead 24-21 3Q. LY OSU smoked NW 52-3 (-27'). OSU has won the last 3 Big 10 Title games and also have won their last 4 appearances. NW enters off a 28-10 (-13') win vs Illinois and we cashed a 4★ LP Totals play on Under 41. OSU is 5-0 SU/3-2 ATS on the season and of course they had their game vs Michigan cancelled last week due to Wolverines' Covid issues. The Buckeyes are +169 ypg and their offense avg 167 ypg more than their foes allow. NW is +38 ypg and their defense holds foes 68 ypg below their avg. NW's offense has been held under 300 yds in 4 of their last 6, but this Buckeyes defense isn't up to par with their past units, allowing 364 ypg and 3 ypg more than their foes avg. NW isn't a flashy team by any stretch of the imagination but their defense keeps games close and HC Fitzgerald is on a 19-10 run as an underdog so we'll call for NW to stay almost within 2 td's.

BIG 12 TITLE GAME - AT&T STADIUM - ARLINGTON, TX

† Oklahoma by 1 over Iowa St - This is OU's 12th Big 12 Title game (10-1 SU/7-3-1 ATS) while this is ISU's first trip. In their mtg earlier this ssn ISU had the narrow edge in both yards (417-414) and FD's (23-22) but cameback from a 17-6 2Q deficit to win 37-30. OU was without two key players in that earlier mtg & will have both RB Stevenson & DE Perkins here. ISU had last week off & are on a 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS run incl beating WVU 42-6 (483-263) in their last gm. Since dropping their F/2 Big 12 gms OU is on a 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS run & had their gm last wk vs WVU canceled. ISU's OFF is led by RB Hall (1357, 6.1, 17 td) & he ran for 139 (5.0) vs OU. ISU QB Purdy is playing much better over the L/3 gms (795, 77%, 7-0) but they face an OU DEF giving up just 295 ypg/16 ppg over their L/4 gms. OU counters with QB Rattler (2512, 69%, 24-7) who threw for 300 yds vs ISU, but threw an int the EZ with 62 sec left to cost OU the gm. ISU's DEF has been solid all ssn though as they have held tms to just 338 ypg. In B12 play this ssn OU was +123 ypg/+18 ppg and held tms to 42 ypg under their ssn avg while ISU was +111 ypg/+16 ypg vs B12 foes & held them to 53 ypg under their ssn avg. These tms appear to be even so while we'll call for OU to win close, ISU is 6-1 ATS the L3Y as a B12 dog & could very well pull another upset vs the Sooners.

SUN BELT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BROOKS STADIUM - CONWAY, SC

COASTAL CAROLINA by 6 over Louisiana - LA is in the SBC title gm for a 3rd straight ssn (lost to App St both times) while CCar makes their 1st trip. In their earlier mtg back in Oct the game was even (CCar 414-413 yd egde) and came down to a made FG by CCar with 4 sec left to win 30-27. A lot has changed since that meeting as CCar has gone on to post a 11-0 SU record (6-2 ATS vs SBC foes) while LA has gone 6-0 SU (4-2 ATS) since their lone loss & have held their L/3 foes to just 268 ypg/14 ppg. CCar's DEF has not been as good, but still solid holding their L/4 foes to 395 ypg/23 ppg & they are holding SBC foes to 86 ypg under their ssn avg. LA's main offense is their run game (230 ypg, 5.8 in the L/4 gms) led by RB's Mitchell (751, 6.2) and Ragas (660, 5.6) & face a CCar run D that gave up 240 rush ypg (7.7) in their last mtg. CCar QB McCall (2170, 69%, 23-2, 473 rush) & RB Marable (844, 5.2) have done an excellent job leading a CCar offense that has avg'd 258 rush ypg (5.4) over the L/4 games. While LA is 9-3-1 ATS as a dog under Napier, we'll lean slightly with CCar who have been proving all season that no moment is too big for them.

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BANK OF AMERICA STADIUM - CHARLOTTE, NC

† Clemson by 4 over Notre Dame - Clemson has won each of the last 5 ACC Title games (5-0 ATS) and the last 3 have been blowouts, winning by 37 ppg. Notre Dame was given 1 year membership to the ACC for football and they've made the most of it by reaching the ACC Title game. The Tigers are out for revenge after losing at Notre Dame earlier this year 47-40 (-5'). QB Lawrence missed that game due to Covid but the Tigers can't use his absence as an excuse as backup QB Ugaialelei threw for 439 yds. ND is +162 ypg on the season and their defense holds foes 103 ypg below their avg. Clemson covered both gms since the loss to ND, including our Dec 5★ GOM winner over VTech 45-10 (-22). ND holds foes to 100 (3.3) rush ypg. RB Etienne hasn't topped 100 rush yds since the 4th gm of the ssn and ND held him to 28 yds on 18 carries in the first game. Brian Kelly is 15-9 as a single digit dog and we think ND's defense can keep them in this game once again. Clemson will get their revenge but the Irish stay within a touchdown.

MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - SAM BOYD STADIUM - LAS VEGAS, NV

† Boise St by 2 over San Jose St - Boise makes their 4th straight MW title game while SJSSt is here for the 1st time. Boise is 14-0 SU vs SJSSt, but SJSSt have covered the L/2 gms. SJSSt is the "host" team but it will played in Vegas due to covid restrictions in San Jose. SJSSt is 6-0 for the first time since 1939 led by transfer QB Starkel (1453, 66%, 13-4) as SJSSt's OFF is avg'g 434 yds/30 pts and have developed a running game over the L/4 gms (195, 5.9) led by RB Nevens (454, 8.9). They face a Boise DEF that has all'd just 308 ypg vs MW foes this season & just held a strong running team in WY to 82 yds last wk. Boise St's OFF is only putting up 325 ypg the L/4 gms and just got starting RB Holani back last wk, however Boise's ST have played a big role in several wins. SJSSt's DEF has been their strength this ssn, all'g 356 ypg/18 ppg and holding foes to 39 ypg under their ssn avg. Boise has the exp edge of playing in this game but due to covid issues have not played consistently this ssn. Dating back to LY SJSSt is on a 9-1 ATS vs MW foes & the Spartans are on a mission. We think they keep this one close & wouldn't be shocked at all by a SJSSt upset.

Texas A&M by 17 over TENNESSEE - A&M makes their first trip to Neyland Stadium. The Aggies won the only SEC mtg back in '16 45-38 in OT. A&M had last week's game against Ole Miss cancelled so this is their last chance to impress the playoff committee. UT took advantage of a depleted Vandy squad ply'g w/an interim HC and ended their school record 6 game losing streak with a 42-17 win (-15). The Vols finished w/a 540-292 yd edge. A&M is +100 ypg and holds foes 88 ypg below their avg. UT is -36 ypg and their offense puts up 47 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. LW was the first time the Vols put up more than 21 pts since their 2nd gm of the ssn. Against 6 common foes (Vandy/Bama/UF/Ark/SC/Aub), A&M is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS, +116 ypg & +8 ppg while UT is 2-4 SU/3-3 ATS, -6 ppg & -30 ypg. HC Pruitt insists on splitting reps between QB's Bailey & Shrout, even pulling Bailey after hitting his first 7 passes LW. They took apart a weak Vandy pass D (#127) but face a much stronger unit in A&M (#28). HC Fisher is 5-0 as an AF and we think they add some style points at the end to impress the committee.

Missouri by 4 over MISSISSIPPI ST - Missouri makes their first trip to Starkville. MO had won 3 straight and 5 of their last six going into last week but was crushed at UGA 49-14 (+14) and outgained 615-200. Mississippi St only trailed 6-3 at half & 16-10 4Q vs Auburn but allowed a touchdown with 6:03 left & lost 24-10 (-7). The Bulldogs were held to 240 yds, had 2 turnovers and were plagued with dropped passes. Missouri had put up 600 yds in B2B games before being held to 200 yds LW. After rushing for 223 & 273 in the last 2 games, the Tigers offense struggled to run vs UGA, finishing with only 22 yds but they could get back on track against a Mississippi St defense that just allowed Aub to run for 218 (6.1). Miss St QB Rogers had shown improvement in three straight games prior to last week's poor performance against the Tigers. Missouri only allows 59% completions and in the last four gms they've only allowed 240 pass ypg. Mississippi St is 0-3 ATS at home this year and Missouri did cover as road chalk vs South Carolina so we will give the Tigers a small lean here.

These tms have met 2 previous times & split the 2 mtgs. Under HC Heupel UCF is in their 3rd bowl game in 3 sn's & they are 1-1 SU/ATS with that win coming LY in the Gasparilla Bowl (-15') 48-25 over Marshall. BYU HC Sitake got BYU to their 4th bowl in 5 sn's and he is 2-1 SU in bowls (1-2 ATS) with the lone SU loss coming LY in the Hawaii bowl 38-34 vs Hawaii.

UCF brought back 16 st's (8 OFF/8 DEF) incl starting QB Gabriel and brought back 12 of the top 13 tkl'rs. UCF's sn started with a 49-21 win at GTech (660-471) and then beat ECU by 23 pts. UCF then lost B2B games for the 1st time since '16 as they lost to Tulsa at home (ended 21-gm home win streak) then lost at Mem 50-49 despite gaining 798 yds (gave up 703 yds). UCF would win 4 of their final 5 gms, with the lone loss being to Cincy by 3 at home. UCF's OFF led by Gabriel (3357, 62%, 30-4) put up 196 ypg above what their foes all'd (#1) but their DEF, which had multiple DEF st's dismissed midsn, all'd 74 ypg more than their foes avg'd (#117).

BYU had an exp'd team coming back in 2020 as they ret'd 15 st's incl QB Wilson. BYU easily won their F/3 gms by a comb'd score of 148-24 but then only beat UTSA by 7 pts. They actually trailed 26-14 vs Hou late 3Q but came back to win 43-26. BYU won their next 4 gms by an avg of 39 pts before traveling mid-wk cross country to face CCar & their unbeaten sn ended as they were stopped 1 yd short in a 22-17 loss. BYU finished the reg sn with a win vs SDSt. QB Wilson was spectacular (3544, 72%, 31-4) & the OFF put up 127 ypg more than what their foes all'd & their OL all'd just 11 sks on 340 passes while the DEF held teams to 62 ypg under their avg.

Two of the nation's premier QB's face off in this gm, but BYU has a huge DEF edge (BYU #52, UCF's #101). UCF does have a huge situational edge as BYU has to travel 2,500+ miles, but UCF is on a 6-17 ATS slide while BYU is 8-3 ATS this sn.

FORECAST: **BYU** RATING: **3★**

These two meet for the first time. HC Holtz has LA Tech bowling for the 7th straight season and they've won all 6 (5-1 ATS) with 3 straight outright upsets including LY beating Miami 14-0 (+7). GASThrn has reached a bowl in all 3 years under HC Lunsford, winning in '18 but losing LY and they are 0-2 ATS. LA Tech won their only prior trip to the NO Bowl in '15, beating another SBC foe, Ark St.

LA Tech entered the season with just 8 starters returning but had all CUSA performers at RB and WR back, a transfer from LSU on the Oline and added solid FCS QB Luke Anthony. They started 2-0 but the offense struggled and they were held to 259 ypg in a 4 gm stretch, losing 3 of the 4. The Bulldogs pulled an outright upset as nearly 2 td dogs, beating UAB 37-34 in OT then had 5 straight games postponed and RB Henderson and WR Hardy opted out! After returning from their break they managed to win at N.Texas. Their decision to add a game at TCU to close the sn proved costly as QB Anthony suffered a gruesome leg inj. LT only avg 325 ypg and is -100 ypg on the sn. Their offense avg 73 ypg less than their foes all and they are now without their top QB, RB, WR & Oline.

GSthrn had 14 starters returning in '20. They had a depleted roster but won the opener then caught LA off their upset over Iowa St & almost pulled the upset. The Panthers won 5 of their next 6, all coming vs weak foes before losing 3 of their last 4 and RB King was OFY in the process. Nine of GSthrn's 12 games have been decided by 8 pts or less. QB Werts is both their leading passer and rush

4★ LA RAMS over Ny Jets - After a rough road trip to the Pacific NW where the Seahawks held them to just 3 pts and 185 yds in a 37 pt defeat, the Jets remain out West to take on a Rams squad that picked up an easy 21 pt win last Thur against the Patriots (17-10 FD & 318-220 yd edges). In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Rams (+1) got a trio of FG's (last w/6:52 remaining) to pick up the low-scoring 9-6 victory. With LA picking up covers in 6 of their L/8 HG's and the Jets failing to cover 5 of their L/6 when listed as an AD (4★ Newsletter Winner against them last week!), we have no issue laying the heavy points in this one. **FORECAST: LA RAMS by 24**

OTHER SELECTIONS

3★ New England over MIAMI - Following a 2-wk trip to LA where they picked up a shutout win over the Chargers and were held to just 3 pts, 10 FD's & 220 yds in a 21 pt loss to the Rams, the Patriots head to South Beach for their 1st of 3 consec DIV matchups to close the regular ssn. The Dolphins are at home for a 3rd consec wkt following a 12 pt win over the Bengals and 6 pt defeat against the Chiefs (KC 30 unanswered pts between 2Q & 3Q). In MIA's Wk 1 trip to Foxboro, the Patriots finished with a 357-269 yd edge (QB Fitzpatrick 3 int's) in the 21-11 victory (-7). This will mark the first time in 7 yrs that NE is a dog to the Dolphins. In fact, TY's trip to BUF (lost 24-21, +4) was the 1st time that the Patriots were getting points against an AFC East foe in 6 ssn's (NE 7-1 ATS as an overall DIV dog dating back to '02!). With the Patriots needing to win out to potentially land the final WC spot in the AFC and MIA being outgained by 73 ypg at home on the ssn, we'll go ahead and call for the visitor to pick up the victory. **FORECAST: New England by 7**

2★ Houston (+) over INDIANAPOLIS - Following a solid 17 pt win against the Raiders where rookie RB Taylor had 150 rush yds and 2 TD's (3★ LP Winner on Over 52.5!), the Colts return home looking for the ssn sweep of a Texans squad that was embarrassed 36-7 on the road against the struggling Bears (CHI 410-263 yd edge). In their 1st meeting 2 wks ago in HOU, QB Watson fumbled what could have been the go-ahead TD at the IND 2 trailing 26-20 (1:28 remaining). Over the past 11 years, when 2 DIV squads play each other twice in a 3-week span, the losing team from the 1st matchup has gone a solid 19-5 ATS in the rematch. And considering that HOU was 2 yds away from a win last time around, we'll call for another tight contest in this one. **FORECAST: INDIANAPOLIS by 1**

OTHER PLAYS

THURSDAY DECEMBER 17TH

La Chargers at LAS VEGAS - Thursday - The Chargers have failed to cover 8 of their L/9 inside of the AFC West including their earlier matchup TY in LA where the Raiders won and covered for a 3rd consec time (Chargers' GW 4-yd TD pass reversed to incomp on the final play). LAC did however rebound from an embarrassing home loss to NE the week prior with a narrow victory over the Falcons (GB 43-yd FG as time expired). The Raiders meanwhile saw their defense give up 44 pts and 456 yds in a 17 pt loss to the Colts (3★ LP Winner on Over 52.5!). While the Raiders are a solid 8-2 ATS against DIV foes coming in, they do have added playoff pressure in this one (need to win out and get some help) along with a key AFC matchup against the Dolphins on deck. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

SATURDAY DECEMBER 19TH

GREEN BAY by 4 over Carolina - The Panthers dropped a 5 pt home contest against the Broncos in their return from bye a week ago. The Packers meanwhile knocked off a struggling Lions squad with QB Rodgers throwing for 290 yds and collecting 4 tit TD's. In the Panthers midssn trip to Lambeau a ssn ago, the Packers (-4) picked up a 24-16 victory despite a 401-388 yd deficit. While GB has covered 10 of their L/16 heading in, the Panthers have gone an impressive 5-0 ATS in recent matchups as an AD including a pair of outright upset victories.

Buffalo by 2 over DENVER - Following a 5 pt win in Charlotte where QB Lock had a huge 280 yd, 4 TD effort, the Broncos return home to take on a Bills squad that finished with 21-14 FD & 334-224 yd edges in their 11 pt victory over PIT. In DEN's late Nov trip to BUF a ssn ago, the Bills finished with 22-9 FD and 424-134 yd edges in the easy 20-3 victory. While BUF has covered 5 straight coming in, they do have a key MNF trip to Foxboro on deck. With the Broncos putting up an impressive 7-2-1 ATS mark as a NDIV HD, we'll lean with the home team in this one.

SUNDAY DECEMBER 20TH

TENNESSEE by 14 over Detroit - This marks the 1st of 2 consec non-conf matchups for the Titans who return home following a blowout win over the Jaguars (RB Henry 215 rush yds, 2 TD's). The Lions meanwhile saw their winning streak snapped at 1 after a 7 pt home loss to the Packers where QB Stafford was lost late with injury (CS here). In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Titans overcame a 15-3 deficit in the 4Q with a pair of TD's (last with 1:13 left) for the 16-15 victory. With the Lions now 0-5 SU (1-4 ATS) since the Titans franchise moved from Houston to Nashville, we'll call for that losing skid to continue here.

Tampa Bay by 1 over ATLANTA - This marks the 1st of 2 matchups between the Bucs and Falcons in the final 3 wks as ATL heads to Tampa for Wk 17. The Bucs returned from their late ssn bye a week ago against the Vikings with a 12 pt victory (MIN 26-17 FD & 335-303 yd edges). The Falcons meanwhile dropped a 20-17 contest in LA against the Chargers (LAC GW 43-yd FG as time expired). In their Wk 17 trip to Tampa a year ago, the Falcons got a 27-yd IR TD in OT for the 28-22 victory (ATL 28-14 FD edge). While the Bucs are a DIV AF for just the 2nd time in the past 8 yrs, they did pick up the cover in Charlotte against the Panthers with relative ease back in Nov (46-23, -6). Despite that victory, we're taking the points with the home team here as ATL has picked up covers in 6 of their L/8 as a DIV HD (ATL Interim HC Morris was TB's HC from '09-'11 before being fired).

Seattle by 3 over WASHINGTON - After getting back on track a week ago against the Jets with an easy 4★ Newsletter Winner (28-12 FD & 410-185 yd edges in a 37 pt victory!), the Seahawks head East for a 5th time TY (3-1 SU/2-2 ATS) to take on a WAS squad that returns home following a an 8 pt upset victory in the desert against the 49ers (game moved from Santa Clara due to Covid) to climb into 1st place in the NFC East. WAS has had some solid success in recent meetings against SEA with a 3-1 SU (1-2-1 ATS) mark including a 17-14 upset victory at SEA in '17 (+8). While we'll go ahead and call for the Seahawks to get the win this time around, covering is another story as they've failed to cover 4 consec AG's while WAS is on a 6-1-1 overall ATS run.

MINNESOTA by 1 over Chicago - The Bears FINALLY ended their 6-gm losing skid LW in dominating fashion against the Texans inside of Soldier Field (CHI 410-263 yd edge). MIN meanwhile had some major issues on ST's against the Bucs as Dan Bailey missed 3 FG's and a PAT in the 12 pt defeat (MIN 27-17 FD & 335-303 yd edges). The Vikings have won and covered 3 consec DIV matchups including a 19-13 MNF victory in Soldier Field where they held the Bears to just 10 FD's and 149 tti yds. However, in their most recent 3-gm homestand, MIN lost outright as 7 pt chalk against the Cowboys, got a 1 pt comeback win versus the Panthers (-3) and needed OT to knock of a 1-win, DD dog JAX squad. With the Bears going an impressive 10-5 ATS against DIV foes, laying too many points in favor of the home team could be risky.

BALTIMORE by 16 over Jacksonville - While the Jaguars continue to drop games at an alarming rate (haven't won outright since the opener) with the Titans handing them a 21 pt home defeat, it's worth mentioning that they've actually covered 4 of their L/6 heading into BAL. The Ravens meanwhile are playing their 1st Sunday contest in 4 wks following a MNF trip to CLE. In their most recent matchup back in '17, the Jags (+3) picked up a 44-7 blowout victory across the pond in London with

substantial FD (24-12) and yard (410-186) advantages (BAL -3 TO's). With the Ravens likely needing to win out to ensure a WC berth in the AFC, we'll call for them to find some early consistency this time around and take care of business.

Cleveland at NY GIANTS - SNF - Flexed to Sunday Night. After going 0-4 ATS against the NFC in both '17 & '19, the Browns are one non-conf cover away from duplicating their '18 campaign against the NFC when they went a perfect 4-0 (3-0 SU & ATS TY w/a 10 pt avg MOV!). They do however head to MeLife on short rest following a MNF matchup against DIV rival BAL. The Giants meanwhile were held to just 7 pts, 10 FD's and 159 yds in a home defeat against the Cardinals. In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Giants knocked off the Browns for the 4th time in 5 contests with a 27-13 win (CLE 21-13 FD & 343-296 yd edges, -2 TO's). While CLE needs a win here to potentially stay alive for the AFC North Title, they are just 1-8 ATS as away chalk dating back to '13 including an 0-2 mark TY. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

ARIZONA by 3 over Philadelphia - Following a 3 pt home win against the Saints in the debut of rookie QB Hurts as a starter (167 pass, 106 rush, 1 TD), the Eagles head back on the road where they've struggled with 4 consec SU & ATS losses (outscored by 10 ppg). The Cardinals ended a 3-gm losing skid LW on the road against the Giants with their defense allowing just 7 pts, 10 FD's and 159 yds in a 19 pt win. In their last meeting back in PHI's Super Bowl winning ssn of '17, the hometown Eagles (-6) jumped out to a 21-0 lead in the 1Q of the eventual 27 pt victory (PHI 419-307 yd edge). While this is clearly not that '17 Eagles squad as they sit at just 4-8-1 on the year, it's also worth mentioning that the Cardinals have dropped 6 of their L/7 as home chalk coming in while also failing to cover 4 of their L/5 overall.

Kansas City at NEW ORLEANS - Potential preview of this year's Super Bowl? The Chiefs head into the Superdome following a 6 pt win in South Beach against the Dolphins where they clinched their 5th consec AFC West Title. The Saints meanwhile saw their 9-gm winning streak snapped LW in PHI (outgained 413-358). In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Chiefs (-6) picked up the 27-21 victory in Arrowhead despite 27-20 FD and 463-326 yd deficits (+2 TO's). While KC has failed to cover 5 of their L/7 matchups against the NFC coming in, we find it hard to pick either side with Drew Brees' return under center still up in the air as of presstime.

DALLAS by 3 over San Francisco - The 49ers and Cowboys have had some memorable matchups in the past including 6 previous meetings in the NFC Championship. The 49ers suffered a crucial loss to WAS a wk ago (19-11 FD & 322-193 yd edges, -2 TO's). The Cowboys meanwhile are back at home for the final 3 wks following a 30-7 win against an undermanned Bengals squad. In their most recent contest back in '17, the Cowboys took the all-time series lead (18-17-1 since 1960) with an easy 30 pt victory (501-290 yd edge). While SF has gone a solid 7-2 ATS in AG's, the Cowboys have covered 5 straight when getting points at home.

Pittsburgh at CINCINNATI - MNF - Following a rough 2 weeks where they were upset at home by WAS and fell by 11 to BUF (began ssn at 11-0), PIT heads to CIN to take on a Bengals squad that's been held to just 10 ppg since the ssn-ending injury to rookie QB Burrow including a 30-7 home loss to the Cowboys (CIN 309-272 yd edge). In their 1st meeting back in mid Nov, the Steelers (-7) picked up an easy 36-10 victory for their 10th consec win in the series (11 pt avg MOV). While another victory should be expected this time around, keep in mind that PIT has failed to cover their L/5 as a DIV AF and that CIN is 6-2 ATS as a DIV HD.
