KEY SELECTIONS

4★ NAVY over East Carolina - This is the AAC opener for each. Navy has won both conference meetings by a combined score of 111-52 with the last matchup in '16. The Middies enter off a bye after beating a middle of the road FCS Holy Cross squad 45-7 with a bye on deck. While Navy is still running the option, they added some 'run & shoot' principals into their offense. QB Perry only completed 9 passes LY (36%), but hit 6-9 in the opener. New EC HC Houston didn't have to defend the triple option during his 5Y at James Madison & they all'd NCSt to rush for 191 (6.2) in the opener. EC is 3-17 as a reg ssn dog of 7+ pts, is on an 11-29 ATS run, is 5-19 ATS in conf road games, & is 1-21-1 ATS vs conf foes with a winning record, while Navy is on a 4-0 ATS reg ssn run vs FBS foes & is 11-6 as home chalk. We'll call for Navy to continue their domination in this series. **FORECAST: NAVY by 17**

3★ Louisiana Tech over BOWLING GREEN - Only 2 meetings were back in '95 & '97, LT is 2-0. The Bulldogs led 20-0 at half LW vs Grambling but only won by 6 and were outgained 455-390. After dominating an FCS foe in week 1 BG stepped up to play Kansas St and was crushed 52-0 (+24'). BG trailed 38-0 at half and was outgained 521-140. LT has a large experience edge (#28 vs #117) and BG's expected starting QB had his waiver denied so they've turned to former BC QB Wade who signed after spring. LT's pass D finished #40 in our PDR LY and they returned 2x All-CUSA CB Robertson. LT is 6-3 as an AF and BG is 1-7 as a HD and 4-11 as a DD dog. We like HC Loeffler but it's going to be tough sledding when they play anyone with a pulse. **FORECAST: Louisiana Tech by 17**

3★ CHARLOTTE over UMass - Last year UMass beat Charlotte 49-31 (-7) in the first meeting. Two weeks ago we went against UMass a 2★ on these pages and upgraded to our 4★ Top LPS because we recognized just how bad UMass would be with 8 starters back from a 4-8 team with a new HC. That became even more evident LW when UMass lost 45-20 vs FCS So Illinois and were outgained 502-337. Charlotte played well LW in a 15 pt loss at App St. They only trailed by 8 pts when their sides-kick was ret'd for a td. QB Reynolds got the start and threw for 296 yds and 4 td's. RB LeMay has topped 100 yds in each of his F/2 and now faces UMass' rush D that allows 219 (5.1) and their pass D has allowed 71% completions. UMass is likely the worst team in the FBS and are 1-5 as an AD. Charlotte is playing inspired under HC Healy so we will back the 49ers for an easy win. **FORECAST: CHARLOTTE by 28**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Iowa (+) over IOWA ST - The Cy-Hawk trophy has been decided by 6 pts or less 5 of the L8Y. LY was the 3rd lowest scoring contest s/1920 & IST was held to ssn lows in yds & FD's. The visitor in this series is 25-13 ATS, but IST is on a 13-7 ATS run. The 'Clones enter off a bye after outlasting FCS Northern Iowa in 3OT. This is IO's road opener and they have a bye on deck. IO picked up it's 3rd shutout in its L/7 B10 games after injuring Rutgers' s'g QB Carter & beating the Knights 30-0 (-18') LW. The Hawkkeys are all'g just 185 ypg. IO is 25-10-2 ATS away from Iowa City, while IST is 1-3 as home chalk. We'll call for IO to pull off the slight upset as the visitor continue's their series dominance. **FORECAST: Iowa by 3**

2★ ARKANSAS over Colorado St - Arkansas is in revenge mode after blowing a 27-9 3Q lead last year with CSU getting the GW td w/08 left for a 34-27 win. We cashed a 3★ Totals Play on UNDER 50' last week in Arkansas' 31-17 (+6) loss at Ole Miss. Ben Hicks hit just 44% for 98 yds before being replaced by A&M transfer Nick Starkel who completed 71% for 201 yds. CSU won easily over an FCS foe. The Rams have put up 545 ypg the F/2 but now they face an SEC defense that brought back 6 starters and has allowed 22 ppg in the F/2. HC Morris is 10-5 ATS at home going back to his final year at SMU and we see some value here when they switch to QB Starkel to spark the offense. **FORECAST: ARKANSAS by 17**

OTHER GAMES

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 13TH

North Carolina at WAKE FOREST - This is actually considered a non-conference game (schools wanted play each other more than once every 7Y). The home team is 4-0 SU/ATS and NC is 5-2 ATS in the series but they've lost the last 2 road trips incl LTH in '12 as 9 pt chalk. The Tar Heels have now pulled B2B upsets after beating Miami last week. True Frosh QB Howell is completing 65% and has yet to throw an int (4-0 ratio) while leading B2B 4Q comebacks. The Tar Heels were outgained by the 'Canes 488-389. QB Jamie Newman has topped 300 yds passing in his last 3 starts incl LY's Bowl. WF plays their 3rd straight Friday game after LW's deceiving 41-21 (-19') win at Rice (Owls 20-19 FD edge). WF was 8-3 as a HD in Clawson's first 4Y then went 0-5 in that role LY. NC hasn't been fav'd in an ACC game since 2016.

Kansas at BOSTON COLLEGE - 1st meeting. KU has lost 18 of their L/22 road openers, but did win LY, snapping a streak of 49 straight losses away from Lawrence. This is the 3rd straight home game for BC. The Jayhawks have their B12 opener on deck and enter off an upset 12-7 (-7) home loss to Coastal Carolina, despite the return of RB Williams, as they were held to only 280 ttl yds. QB Stanley only threw for 107 yds & had 2 int's. BC cruised in their blowout win over FCS Richmond LW. The Eagles only allowed VT to rush for 98 (2.3) in their opener. BC is on a 16-5 reg ssn ATS run & is 7-1 as DD chalk vs FBS foes. KU is 23-37-2 as an AD & is on a 18-29 ATS run.

† Washington St at HOUSTON - NRG Stadium is 5 miles from UH's campus so we are treating this like a UH home game. UH has played here 3 times s/12, winning all 3 including beating Oklahoma in '16. This is Wazzu's road opener and they have their P12 opener on deck, while UH has their AAC opener on deck. UH followed up their opening ssn loss at Oklahoma with an easy win over FCS Prairie View A&M LW. Wazzu meanwhile has B2B blowout wins to enter the ssn, the latest over FCS Northern Colorado. UH is 19-10 ATS vs non-conf foes & is 13-3-1 as a regular ssn dog, but Wazzu is on a 32-16 ATS run & is 4-0 as road chalk.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 14TH

Ohio State by 14 over INDIANA - This is the B10 opener for each & OSU has won 24 straight. This is the Buckeyes road opener, while IU has yet to play outside of Indiana. After all'g negative ttl yds in the 1H of their wk 1 win over FAU, OSU all'd just 273 yds LW in their blowout over Cincy in a game many thought would be close. The Hoosiers followed up their close opening ssn win over Ball St with a blowout LW over FCS Eastern Illinois. IU QB Penix is completing 63% of his passes & OSU is all'g 62% completions. OSU is on a 5-9 ATS run & is 1-5 as road chalk. We have this game right at the line.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 7 over Kansas St - Kansas St has lost 3 straight road openers. MST has their SEC opener on deck, while KSt has lost 5 of their L/6 non-conf road gms vs P5 foes, but does have a bye on deck. LY KSt was held to a ssn low 213 ttl yds in their blowout loss. The Bulldogs led Southern Miss 28-7 mid 3Q & won 38-15 (-16'). The win may prove costly as QB Stevens was inj'd (CS) and true frosh Shrader (PS#23) was 7-11-71-0-0 & Keytaon Thompson returned to the tm LW. The 'Cats tit'd 500+ yds in B2B gms for the 1st time in schl history and enter off a 52-0 (-24') shutout of Bowling Green, as they all'd just 5 FD's & 140 yds. KSt is 8-3 ATS vs non-conf foes, but is also 13-22 ATS in their 1st away game. MST is 19-11 as home chalk.

COLLEGE MARQUEES!!!!!!

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NC State by 8 over WEST VIRGINIA - WV hasn't hosted a non-conf P5 team s/16. The Mountaineers have their B12 opener on deck, while this is NCST's road opener. After being held under 300 yds in their opener vs FCS James Madison, WV was limited to just 171 yds & avoided being shutout late 4Q in their 38-7 (+13') loss at Mizzou LW. The Wolfpack have B2B blowout wins to open the ssn following their shutout over FCS Western Carolina & has allowed a total of 375 ttl yds thru 2 gms. WV has been slow to the scheme changes brought in from new HC Brown. NCST is 9-3 as road chalk & is 12-5 ATS vs non-conf FBS foes, while WV has failed to cover their L/3 as a HD. **Maryland by 8 over TEMPLE** - The visitor in this series is 7-0 ATS. MD is in revenge mode after losing at home 35-14 (-14') LY & has won 6 of their L/7 road openers by 16 ppg. MD has a bye on deck. TU enters off a bye following their 56-12 win over one of the worst FCS programs (Bucknell) in new HC Rod Carey's debut. QB Anthony Russo, who threw for 409 (78%) figures to be challenged more this week. New MD HC Locksley, who was Bama's OC the L2Y, has the Terps ply'g like the Tide early on, with B2B blowouts including LW's 63-20 (-1) domination over #21 'Cuse that featured their most pts ever vs a ranked foe. This is a big step up in class for Temple and we'll call for MD to begin the season 3-0 and win by over a td.

CINCINNATI by 10 over Miami, Oh - 124th meeting! This is the longest running non-conf series in CFB. Cincy has won the Victory Bell 13 straight yrs and got a 21-0 (+1) shutout LY, while the dog is 6-0. The 'Cats have yet to leave Ohio and have a bye on deck. MU led FCS Tenn Tech 41-3 in the 4Q of their blowout win LW, while Cincy fell flat in their showdown vs Ohio St, getting shutout 42-0 (+15') and held to 273 yds. The RedHawks used a 1-2 combo of RB's Tyre Shelton & Zach Kahn to lead a ground attack that finished with 190 (4.8) & the 'Cats all'd 270 (5.9) rush LW. Cincy is 8-16 ATS vs non-conf foes, 5-11 ATS off a SU loss & 6-11 ATS hosting FBS foes, while MU is 16-10 as an AD & on an 8-2 ATS run. We'll call for the dog in this series to cover a 7th straight yr.

PENN ST by 16 over Pittsburgh - 100th meeting. LY PSU only led 14-6 at the half, but outscored Pitt 37-0 in the 2H. This is the Panthers road opener, while the Nittany Lions have a bye on deck. Under HC Narduzzi, Pitt has 10 outright upsets and 6 have come on the road. PSU got off to a slow start LW, trailing Buffalo 10-7 at the half, but outscored the Bulls 38-3 in the 2H, however did finish with just 357 ttl yds & 14 FD's. Pitt led Ohio 17-3 at the half and didn't allow a td until 4:04 remained in their 20-10 (-4) win. The Panthers are all'g just 261 ypg. Pitt is 13-6 as an AD & we'll call for the Panthers to keep this game slightly closer than expected.

ILLINOIS by 7 over Eastern Michigan - 1st meeting. Illinois has their B10 opener on deck, while Eastern Michigan is travelling for the 3rd straight week, but only has FCS Central Conn St next. The Eagles had lost 38 straight games vs current B10 foes, but have now won each of the L2Y (beat bowl bound Purdue LY!). The Illini trailed UConn 13-0 LW, but scored 24 straight and held on to win their first non-conf road game in a dozen years, 31-23 (-21'). RB Corbin DNP (inj), but should return here. EM trailed KY 31-17, but allowed a td & the frontdoor cover with :54 left in LW's loss. Last year the Eagles ply'd 3 straight away games early in the season and took San Diego St to OT in that 3rd game so HC Creighton will have his team prepared. EM is on a 26-11-1 ATS run & is 14-2 as an AD, while Illinois is 16-28 as home chalk & is on a 10-20 ATS run. We'll call for EM to keep this game slightly closer than expected.

GEORGIA by 28 over Arkansas St - Georgia is 2-0 all-time vs Arkansas St but 0-2 ATS and they haven't met since 2001. The Dawgs dominated an FCS foe last week but they have Notre Dame on deck. Ark St is off an impressive 43-17 (+1) road win vs UNLV. The RedWolves led 30-3 3Q and outgained the Rebels 498-300. QB Bonner is completing 62% and WR Bayless already has 281 yds. The Dawgs are 2-5 ATS vs non-Power 5 teams under HC Smart while Ark St is just 4-12 ATS vs non-conf foes the L3Y. This is a prime look-ahead spot for UGA but HC Anderson is 0-3 as a dog of 20+ pts.

Air Force by 3 over COLORADO - These teams have met 16 times (AF trails series 12-4) but the last mtg was back in 1974. AF comes into this gm fresh off a bye while CU is off a huge comeback win at home over former rival Nebraska 34-31 in OT (trailed 17-0 3Q) and has their P-12 opener on deck. AF's option is tough to prep for & they bring back 7 st'rs on OFF while CU returns just 4 DEF st'rs. The Falcons also return 7 DEF st'rs who go against a CU offense avg'g 470 ypg & 43 ppg. AF is an impressive 10-3-1 ATS as an AD the L5Y & are 17-5-1 ATS vs non-conf foes over that same span. AF also has the edge in experience (#25 vs #88) as well as the coaching edge with CU having a 1st yr HC & AF HC Calhoun being in year 13 here. We like AF to leave Boulder with the outright upset.

San Diego St by 10 over NEW MEXICO ST - SDSt leads series 9-1-1 & last won here 26-16 back in '13 which was also NMST's home opener. NMST is just 2-9 SU in their L/11 home openers w/ both wins vs FCS foes. The SDSt DEF has looked real impressive so far all'g just 208 ypg & 49 rush ypg! SDSt's OFF showed life LW in their upset win at UCLA (373 yds/23 pts) while NMST is off 2 lopsided losses at Bama & Wash St (outscored 120-17). SDSt is 15-27 ATS vs non-conf foes under HC Long, but NMST is 2-4 as a HD the L2Y incl losses as a HD vs 2 MW teams last ssn. These tms offenses are ranked close, but SDSt has the large edge in both DEF and ST and are the more exp'd team, which is why we think that will be enough to get them a 10-pt road win.

Florida Atlantic by 1 over BALL ST - FAU steps down in class to face Ball St after getting blown out at Ohio St and UCF. The Owls had played Ohio St tough 2 weeks ago, outscoring the Buckeyes 21-17 over the final 3Q but they were crushed by UCF LW 48-14 (+12') and outgained 574-314. The Owls have allowed 275 rush (5.8) over the F/2 games. Ball St enters after an easy win over an FCS foe. The Cardinals did trail 14-7 after giving up 2 td drives to start the game. FAU is 3-8 as an AF and 1-5 ATS in non-conf play. Ball St is just 2-6 as a HD but also 8-4 ATS in non-conf play under HC Neu. We will call for FAU to get in the win column by the slimmest of margins.

NOTRE DAME by 28 over New Mexico - First meeting & both teams are off a bye. New Mexico HC Davie coached at Notre Dame from '97-'01 but won't make the trip to South Bend as he is recovering from a health issue. ND's offense put up 423 yds & 35 pts vs an improved Louisville team 2 weeks ago while NM (just 2 ret DEF st'rs) gave up 558 yds & 31 pts to FCS Sam Houston St. ND is on an 0-5 ATS run as a favorite of 17+ pts, but they are 5-0 ATS in their L/5 home openers while NM is just 5-9 ATS as a 20+ pt dog the L7Y. ND has a massive gm at Georgia next week and could pull starters if up big, but the Irish have a significant edge on both OFF and DEF while NM still is not fully settled on a QB & could try a couple different options. Given the gap in overall talent, we like Notre Dame to win by 4 TD's.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over Akron - The Chippewas are 10-2 vs the Zips s/98, but lost 17-10 LY ending a 7 gm winning streak. LY after trailing 17-0 at HT, CM got within 17-10 3Q, but were SOD at UA6 & CM42 their L/2 drives. The Zips are just 1-6 in Mount Pleasant s/96, losing the L/3 incl 35-14 (+3) the LTH in '15. Akron is just 8-21 vs MAC West foes s/09, but have at least 1 win vs them each of L/6 yrs. CM covered as a 15 pt HF in their opener vs solid FCS foe Albany 38-21 but last week ran into the buzz saw of Wisconsin losing 61-0 as a 35 pt AD. The Zips lost their opener 42-3 at Illinois as a 18 pt AD, and LW lost 31-20 at home as a 8 pt HD against a very young UAB team. With Miami, FL on deck, we look for CM to be fully focused here as they try to end a 8 gm MAC losing streak (after winning L/5 vs MAC in '18) but do expect the game to be close.

UCF by 1 over Stanford - Stanford is in a P12 sandwich and on the 2nd of B2B away games. The Cardinal has only lost 3 of 15 games vs current AAC foes. UCF is 2-11 SU hosting a P5 foe, but did beat Pitt 45-14 (-13) LY. There could be a QB controversy brewing in Orlando after true frosh Dillon Gabriel threw 2 more td's in LW's 48-14 (-12) win at FAU after throwing 3 in the opener as Brandon Wimbush is inj'd (CS). Stanford led USC 17-3 early 2Q, but was outscored 42-3 in the final 43 minutes of regulation as QB Costello was held out, but should return here (CS). Stanford is on a 35-22 ATS run, while UCF is on a 24-10 ATS run & is 11-4 as home chalk. There's no line at presstime.

Alabama by 31 over SOUTH CAROLINA - The last time these two met was in 2010 and SC snapped #1 Bama's 19 game winning streak. The Gamecocks have lost their last 5 SEC home openers (1-4 ATS). Bama barely needed to show up last week to beat New Mex St and SC is their toughest game in Sept so we will likely see their best effort here. SC is off a win over FCS Charleston Southern where they put up 72 pts and 775 yds as they clearly wanted to let true frosh QB Ryan Hilinski get as much work as possible after 3Y starter Ryan Bentley was inj'd in the opener (out vs Bama). Hilinski hit 80% for 282 yds but now he gets thrown to the wolves against Bama's D. HC Muschamp is in his preferred role as a dog (10-3 as dog L2Y) but Bama has won their L/2 SEC road openers by a combined score of 121-7 so we will roll with the tide here.

Army by 24 over UTSA - This will be UTSA's first time playing a Service Academy and first time playing against the triple-option. Army is off an emotional overtime loss at Michigan in which we did pick up a 3★ winner on the Black Knights (+22) in this Newsletter and we also won a 3★ on Under 48. Before you think Army is due for a letdown, think back to last year when Army was off an emotional OT loss at #5 Oklahoma then traveled to 4-0 Buffalo and whooped the Bulls 42-13 (+7). The Roadrunners gave up 398 (9.4) rush yds and trailed 49-0 3Q LW at Baylor. A large chunk of Army's roster comes from Texas and they usually do well in the state (5-2-1 ATS L4Y). Army has the edge on offense and defense and there will be no let down from the disciplined men of West Point. Could we go back to Army for our Totals GOM?

Usc by 4 over BYU - USC is 2-0 SU all time vs BYU & the road team is 2-0 ATS in the series including USC's last trip here (also last mtg), in '04, when #1 USC won 42-10 (-26') with a 514-221 yd edge. After just getting by Fresno St 31-23 in the opener as a 13.5 pt HD, USC faced Stanford LW with both teams without their starting QB's. True Frosh QB Kedon Slocet 3 USC frosh records in their dominating 45-20 win over #3 Stanford as a 3 pt HF. BYU after opening with a disappointing 30-12 loss (+6.5) to rival Utah, came from behind to upset Tennessee 29-26 in OT as a 3' pt AD. While you might expect as easy win for USC, this will be the true freshman's first road start in the altitude of Provo, where BYU was not a dog all of last year. While we expect USC to win, BYU will keep it close to the line.

MINNESOTA by 13 over Georgia Southern - First mtg. Minn is off a double OT win at Fresno St 38-35, while GS ran for 395 yds in a close 26-18 win over FCS Maine. Minn faced an option tm last ssn in their bowl gm (G/Tech) and know what it takes to slow the option down as they held G/Tech to 119 rush yds under their ssn avg. This ssn Minn is holding tms to 116 rush ypg & have 7 str's back on DEF. GS HC Lunsford was 4-1 ATS vs non-conf LY & was 6-3 ATS off a SU win LY, but Minn HC Fleck is good vs non-conf foes going 18-8-1 ATS as a HC. GS is still without RB Kennedy, who was their leading returning rusher & receiver this ssn & Minn is 19-1 SU in their last 20 home gms vs non-conf foes. We'll forecast Minn to win here by nearly 2 TDs.

NORTHWESTERN by 17 over UNLV - NW has won 9 of their L/12 home openers, but did lose vs Duke LY. While the 'Cats have won 23 of their L/29 hosting non-conference foes, they went 0-2 SU in that role LY. This is UNLV's road opener and they have a bye on deck. The Rebels are 2-15 vs B10 foes. NW enters off a bye following their 17-7 (+6') loss at Stanford. QB Hunter Johnson started, but TJ Green also saw time and was much more effective until being inj'd & OFY. UNLV trailed Ark St 30-3 mid 3Q & lost 43-17 (-1), getting held to 300 yds & 14 FD's in the process. It usually takes the 'Cats a few games to get going so the early bye could be a detriment. NW is 0-4 as home chalk & the dog in NW games is 13-2-1, while UNLV is 24-11 as an AD.

Oklahoma St by 19 over TULSA - This is the 75th meeting between these in-state rivals. Oklahoma St has won 7 of the L/8 including 6 straight. TU has won 12 of their L/13 home openers. The Pokes have their B12 opener on deck. The Golden Hurricane responded from their opening season loss at Michigan St, where they were held to -73 rush yds, with 256 (4.7) in their 34-16 (-6) win at San Jose St. Tulsa is allowing just 326 ypg. Oklahoma St was never threatened in their blowout win LW vs FCS McNeese. After rushing for 352 (6.8) in their opener, the Pokes threw for 413 (72%) LW. Tulsa's defense is improved, but Oklahoma St just has too many offensive weapons at their disposal. Oklahoma St is on a 5-2 ATS run vs FBS foes, while Tulsa is 5-10 as a HD.

Memphis by 21 over SOUTH ALABAMA - 2nd mtg. LY was 1st mtg when Memphis was -31' but led just 31-27 after 3Q's and despite South Alabama all g 3 TD's in the 4Q the Jags covered (52-35 loss). Both teams are off wins against FCS teams. Memphis is 0-3 ATS in their L/3 road openers, but South Alabama is 7-11 as a HD since 2012. Memphis has the large edge in offense, defense, and overall experience (#45 vs. #125), plus Memphis has just a bye on deck. Memphis HC Norvell was 3-1 LY ATS as a 20+ pt favorite while South Alabama HC Campbell was 1-2 as a HD LY. South Alabama is all g just 271 ypg on DEF & is avg'g 426 yds on OFF this ssn, but their biggest issue is TO's (8 in 2 gms). But Memphis is holding teams to 216 ypg this ssn & has the big experience edge (#45 vs #125) which is why we like them by 3 TDs.

† Louisville by 13 over Wku - These two schools are 111 miles apart but they are playing this game in Nashville. They met for the 1st time since 1998 last year. WKU was off a loss to an FCS foe and nearly upset Lville as over 3 td dogs, losing by just a fg. WKU was again off an FCS loss last week when they upset FIU 20-14 (+7). The 'Toppers never trailed and outgained the Panthers 339-217, giving HC Helton his first win as HC. Lville only led FCS E Kentucky 14-0 at half LW but went on to win 42-0. Lville has rushed for 286 (6.7) ypg incl 249 (5.3) vs Notre Dame. Both Lville's Hawkins and WKU's Walker have topped 100 rush in the F/2 gms. Both teams look inspired under new HC's. We doubt Lville overlooks anyone considering their 2-10 ssn LY so we will call for them to get HC Satterfield his first win here over an FBS foe.

MICHIGAN ST by 14 over Arizona St - Michigan St is in revenge mode after never trailing LY until allowing the GW 28 yd fg as time expired. Arizona St has lost 9 of their L/11 road openers including at San Diego St LY. Both schools have their conference openers on deck. Sparty's OFF finally showed signs of life LW in their 51-17 (-15') win over Western Michigan, which snapped a streak of 9 straight games that finished UNDER the total. The Sun Devils struggled vs FCS Sacramento St (2-8 SU LY) last Friday, scoring the game-deciding td w/4:42 remaining. They had just 78 yds at HT. Arizona St is 3-7 as a non-conf dog of less than 13 pts. We'll side with Sparty in what should be another low-scoring affair.

CALIFORNIA by 10 over North Texas - First mtg. Last week we used Under 43 as Saturday's Button 9 Comp (2-0 TY!) in Cal's upset win over Washington, getting the GW fg with :08 left. NT fell behind 21-0 1Q last week at SMU. They trailed 49-20 late and added a td in garbage time. The Mean Green have given up 480 ypg in their F/2 incl 456 vs FCS Abilene Christian. The loss of LY's 2 All-CUSA starting CB's was their biggest concern in camp and they've allowed 68% completions in the F/2 (283 pass ypg). This will be QB Fine's toughest test to date, facing Cal's secondary which finished #1 in our PDR last year and brought back all 4 starters. NT did pull an upset LY at Ark and they are 3-2 ATS ply'g 2nd of B2B road games. Cal is 0-4-1 as a HF and 1-4 ATS vs non-conf foes while HC Littrel is 10-5 vs non-conf so we will lean with the dog in this one. Will this be our Totals Game of the Month?

LIBERTY by 3 over Buffalo - Only prior meeting was also LTH, a 27-24 Liberty win in Buffalo's last season in the then 1-AA (now FCS). Liberty moved to the FBS LY under former UB HC Turner Gill, but he resigned at the end of last season. The Flames are 3-8 SU all-time vs current MAC teams with their last being a 17-10 loss (+17) to Kent St in 2013. (last SU win 27-23 over Ball St in '10). Liberty was 5-1 SU & ATS in Lynchburg last year but lost 24-0 to Syracuse as a 19 pt HD in their home opener. Both teams are off losses where they led at HT. Liberty led 14-7 at Louisiana LW as a 14 pt dog, but lost 35-14 allowing 407 yds rush 98.8 ypc). The Bulls led 10-7 at Penn St as a 31 pt dog but lost 45-13, with Penn St throwing a 56 yd pass with 3:03 left for the backdoor cover. The Bulls put up 184 rush (3.2 ypc) vs Penn St. With Liberty having 15 ret starters compared to Buffalo's 8, we look for that experience to be the difference here and will take the Flames & the points.

TROY by 3 over Southern Miss - These two last met in 2016, Troy won 37-31 (+10') on the road. SM is playing their 2nd of 3 straight road games sandwiched between two SEC foes so full attention will go to this game. Southern Miss held their own LW at Mississippi St. They were only outgained last week by 42 yards and trailed 31-16 until they gave up a late td. Troy beat up on FCS Campbell in wk1 then had a bye last week. This is HC Lindsay's first game vs an FBS foe. This is a matchup of 2 of the best defenses in CUSA and SBC. Southern Miss allowed 20 ppg LY while Troy allowed 22 and both have 6 starters back. It's tough to play against these teams in their respective roles but with 2 strong defenses, the Under could be in the mix for our Totals GOM!

AUBURN by 31 over Kent St - First meeting, Kent St is 0-14 all-time vs current SEC tms, losing by an avg of 37 ppg incl a 21 point loss at Ole Miss LY. The Tigers were off an emotional win vs Oregon last week and only led Tulane 14-6. Now they are in a prime look-ahead spot with their SEC opener at A&M on deck. Kent needed overtime to beat Kennesaw St (#9 in FBS) last week. The Golden Flashes trailed 13-3 2Q. The Tigers are on a 7-19-1 run as HF and while they've won 25 straight reg ssn mtgs vs current Group of 5 teams, those have only come by 28 ppg. Auburn is also 1-8 ATS off a SU win.

Florida by 10 over KENTUCKY - The Gators are out for revenge after seeing their 31 game series win streak end against the 'Cats. The Gators were off a bye and dominated FCS UT Martin 45-0 last week. Kentucky backers were fortunate for a 2nd consecutive week when the 'Cats got a front door cover against Eastern Mich, scoring their final td just :54 left. QB Terry Wilson was injured in the 2H and is OFY. Bkp QB Sawyer Smith (transfer from Troy) led 2 td drives. QB Franks completed less than 50% LY but the 'Cats have had to entirely rebuild their secondary and E Mich threw for 337 yds last week. The series edge clearly belongs to Florida and they were 3-0 as AF LY.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 10 over Georgia State - 2nd mtg, first was last ssn. LY WMich was a 7' point favorite at GSSt and never trailed in a 34-15 win. WMich is off a 51-17 blowout loss at Mich St and travel to Syracuse next week, so their best chance for a win is here, while GSSt is 2-0 for the 1st time in program history after barely winning LW vs FCS Furman 48-42. GSSt is just 2-5-1 as an AD under HC Elliott, but upset Tenn at Rocky Top 2 weeks ago. GS is also 1-6-3 ATS in road gms dating back to 2017. Both teams have DEF's all'g over 450 ypg & 30 ppg this ssn, which means this gm could feature a lot of pts. Both tms are exp'd (WMich #10, GSSt #22) but we will back the home team here as GSSt has not had much overall success on the road the L3Y.

SMU by 21 over Texas St - 1st meeting as FBS members. In-state rivals are still separated by 225 miles. SMU has won only 6 of their L/22 reg ssn games vs FBS foes, but has won each of their first 2 this year following their 49-27 (-3') rout of NTx. QB Buechele (Texas transfer) threw his first 3 td passes for the Ponies, who also ran for 211 (5.4). TXSt has lost 8 of their L/9 non-conf road games (won in 3OT at Ohio in '16) & has their SBC opener on deck, but the Ponies have the Iron Skillet rivalry next week. The 'Cats finished with a 444-293 yd edge, but all'd a 72 yd IR td and couldn't hold onto a 14-3 late 1H lead, losing to WY 23-14 (+7). SMU is 4-0 ATS in the 2nd of B2B home games & is 10-3-1 ATS in reg ssn non-conf games, while TXSt is 6-11 as a DD AD. The Ponies already have a win over a better SBC team and should handle TXSt with little issues.

Duke by 4 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - 1st mtg, MT has pulled outright upsets over 2 ACC foes (GT in '12 and Cuse in '17). Both teams replaced their veteran QB's this year and lost their openers as big underdogs and both enter after beating an FCS foe LW. Duke QB Harris threw for 345 and rushed for 83, accounting for 5 td's. MT QB O'Hara was respectable vs Michigan then threw for 367 and rushed for 103 last week. The Blue Devils have the experience edge (#63 vs #114) but MT typically takes one Power-5 foe seriously. The Blue Raiders have a bye on deck before a trip to Iowa so this is their shot to pull an upset and they did give Kentucky a run for their money LY. Duke much prefers the underdog role (1-6 as fav LY) so we will call for MT to keep it closer than expected.

WASHINGTON by 17 over Hawai'i - 6th meeting with the last one coming in '14. In that gm UW went to UH as 17' favorites but won just 17-16. LTH (2011) Washington was just -5' but beat Hawaii 40-32. UH is off of their 2nd straight win vs a P-12 team (31-28 vs Oreg St) while Washington lost at home to Cal 20-19 LW. The Huskies are giving up just 289 ypg this ssn, but have just 2 returning st'rs on DEF & are facing a UH OFF that is avg'g 542 ypg & 38 ppg. UW is just 2-8 ATS the L2Y as a DD favorite, but UH is 2-6 ATS vs non-conf foes in that same span and are on a 3-8 ATS slide on the road. We have been impressed with UH, but we think UW bounces back at home by over 2 TD's.

PURDUE by 4 over TCU - Purdue has a bye on deck, while TCU enters off a bye following their opening week win over Ark Pine Bluff in a game they only had a 182-140 yd edge at the half with QB's Duggan & Delton splitting reps. The Frogs have won 11 of their L/14 road openers, including 5 straight, but do have the Iron Skillet rivalry on deck. After failing to hold onto a 17 pt 2H lead in their opener, Purdue increased a 14-10 HT lead to 28-10 in the 4Q, but QB Sindelar, who threw for 509 yds & 5 td's, was inj'd on the final possession (CS). The FREE Button 9 B12/B10 comp play on Fridays is now 2-0 TY! Purdue HC Brohm is 15-8 as home chalk, while TCU is on a 14-23 ATS run.

TECHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK..... SMU

Clemson by 24 over SYRACUSE - Last year Syracuse nearly upset Clemson for the 2nd consecutive season after QB Lawrence was inj'd. Bkp QB Brice converted a 4th down, saving the Tigers season as a loss would have likely ended their playoff hopes. The Orange have struggled to get their offense going, scoring just 44 pts in their F/2 games after avg 40 ppg LY. The Oline has struggled which resulted in 4 sks and 70 rush yds (2.4) last week at Maryland. The bigger surprise though was the play of their defense who was off a shutout then allowed 63 pts and 650 yds. Clemson is off deceiving 14 pt win (-16') over TX A&M. The Aggies final td came with just :06 left. Syracuse allowed 354 (7.9) rush yds LW and now faces LY's Doak Walker finalist Travis Etienne who has 258 (9.2). Cuse is a dangerous dog (9-3 L2Y) and HC Babers seems to always keep this game closer than expected.

VIRGINIA by 11 over Florida St - Last meeting was in '14. UVA is just 3-14 all-time vs FSU but they've covered the last 2 and won 2 of the last 5. After blowing their opener vs Boise St, FSU responded by barely beating ULM last week, winning in OT 45-44 (-22') thanks to a missed PAT. UVA enters off an FCS win over former 'Hoos HC Mike London and William & Mary. The 'Noles put up over 500 yds for the first time under Willie Taggart, with QB Blackman throwing for 282 (75%) and RB Akers went for 193 (5.4). UVA has allowed just 71 (2.2) rush yds and 48% completions. FSU is on a 1-6 ATS run, went 1-4 ATS on the road and are 3-11-2 ATS vs ACC foes, while UVA is 17-11 ATS hosting FBS foes.

Oklahoma by 23 over UCLA - This is OU's road opener and the Sooners have won an FBS high 20 straight true road games. UCLA has lost 8 straight vs Top 10 foes including 49-21 (+29') LY in Norman. OU has a bye on deck, while the Bruins have their P12 opener next. The Sooners starters got plenty of rest in their blowout over FCS South Dakota LW. UCLA meanwhile, was outg'd 373-261 & outFD'd 22-16 in their 23-14 (-8) home loss vs SDSt, as we've won our Top LPS 4★ Total (UNDER 45) for the 2nd straight week (LPS Totals 5-2, 71% & our GOM goes Saturday!). The Bruins all'd Aztec QB Agnew to throw for a career high 293 yds & OU's QB has won the Heisman in B2B years. OU is 20-12-1 ATS away, while UCLA is 1-8 ATS hosting non-conf foes & 2-8 as a HD.

NEBRASKA by 21 over Northern Illinois - Nebraska won the first 2 meetings by a combined score of 108-31, but lost the meeting 21-17 (-11') here in '17. The 'Huskies have their B10 opener on deck, while NIU is on the 2nd of B2B away gms, but does have a bye on deck. Nebraska appeared to be in total control LW, allowing just 84 yds in the 1H & leading Colorado 17-0 late 3Q before allowing the tying td w/:46 left and losing in OT 34-31 (-4'). The Huskies only trailed 21-17 at the half LW at Utah, but were shutout in the 2H & lost 35-17 (+21'). NIU is avg just 79 (2.6) rush ypg, while Nebraska is allowing just 86 (2.1) rush ypg. Nebraska had won 7 in a row ATS before losing their first 2 this yr, while NIU is on a 9-14 ATS run. We'll call for the 'Huskies to re-gain their confidence and win by 3 td's.

Texas by 24 over RICE - This is a Rice home game in Houston, but it's listed as a neutral field gm because its being played at NRG Stadium. These in-state rivals have met 94 times and TX has won 41 of the L/42 including 13 straight. The 'Horns are in an LSU/OKSt sandwich. TX is off an emotional 45-38 (+6') slugfest loss vs LSU. The 'Horns had opportunities, highlighted by their failure to score twice in the 1Q when they were SOD from the 1 & 2 yd line. After last Friday's 41-21 (+19') loss vs WF, Rice has lost 12 straight games vs P5 foes by an avg of 33 ppg. The Owl's lost starting QB Green to injury in the 1Q (CS) but did finish with a 20-19 FD edge. Harvard grad transfer Tom Stewart hit 19-30-185-1-0 in relief. Rice is on a 6-2 ATS run & is 7-4 as a DD dog. With a big game on deck for the 'Horns, we'll call for the Owl's to keep this game slightly closer than expected.

Texas Tech by 1 over ARIZONA - Texas Tech has won 8 of their L/9 road openers. Both schools have a bye on deck. Arizona was off a bye LW and led FCS Northern Arizona 51-13 at the half & finished with 720 yds including 431 (9.4) rush. After opening the season allowing only 289 yds, the Red Raiders allowed just 131 LW in their blowout over 38-3 (-34') win over UTEP, with the Miner's scoring their lone pts on a 45 yd fg w/5:32 remaining. AZ is 21-10-1 as a HD. We like the job Matt Wells is doing so far with Texas Tech, but this is a step up in competition & we feel Arizona will keep it slightly closer than expected.

3★ GREEN BAY over Minnesota - Following a 16 pt win LW at home against ATL (+3 TO's, 345-269 yd deficit) where we picked up a 3★ LP & Newsletter Winner, MIN heads to Wisconsin to take on a GB squad that they've gone 3-0-1 SU against the past 2 yrs. In a defensive slugfest last Thur to open the 100th NFL ssn against CHI, GB delivered a 10-3 victory (Marquee Winner on the Under 46.5!) despite just 13 FD's & 213 ttl yds. With the Packers having gone 9-2-1 ATS in home openers, having the advantage of extra rest and playing 5 of their next 6 in Lambeau, we'll call for them to move to 2-0 on the young season.

2★ NY GIANTS over Buffalo - After erasing a 16-0 Jets lead last weekend on the road and cashing a 3★ LP Winner, the Bills (370-223 yd edge, 4-1 TO deficit) find themselves inside of MetLife Stadium for a 2nd consec week to take on a Giants squad that fell LW on the road against the Cowboys in ugly fashion. In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Giants went into BUF as a 6 pt dog and left with a 24-10 victory. While the Bills' travel plans are light early on as they play their first 4 gms in the NY/NJ area, keep in mind that the Giants are 12-5 ATS against AFC opponents.

OTHER PLAYS

Tampa Bay at CAROLINA - Thursday - The Panthers are back at home for a 2nd consec week following a 3 pt loss LW to the Rams where they were forced into 3 TO's. The Bucs meanwhile suffered 4 TO's (incl 2 IR TD's) in the 14 pt loss to the 49ers at home (TB 298-264 yd edge). In their 2 matchups of a year ago, the home squad claimed both the SU and ATS victories with a 6 pt avg cover. With the Panthers covering just 1 of their past 5 as a DIV HF and the Bucs going just 3-7-4 ATS as an AD, check back on Thursday to see which way we decide to lean. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

TENNESSEE by 6 over Indianapolis - The Jacoby Brissett nearly got off to a surprising start following a narrow OT loss on the road against the favored Chargers. The Titans meanwhile overcame the hype in CLE for any easy 43-13 victory thanks in part to a 3-0 TO edge. The last time these 2 split the ssn series was way back in 2011 as since that year the Colts have earned the sweep on 6 occasions (incl LY) with TEN coming out victorious just twice (in '17). With the Titans (9-4 ATS vs DIV foes) playing at home for the only time in the month of Sept and having a short week on deck (Thur at JAX), this is a crucial early season matchup for them here if they want to make any noise in the AFC South for 2019.

LA Chargers by 6 over DETROIT - Following a 27-27 tie LW in the desert against the Cardinals where they blew a 24-6 Q4 lead, the Lions head back to Ford Field where they've gone just 4-11 ATS as a HD. The Chargers head East after an OT win over the Colts where bkp RB Ekeler posted 154 ttl yds & 3 TD's. In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Chargers overcame a 21-3 deficit mid 2Q in the eventual 33-28 victory. With LA posting an impressive 5-1-1 ATS mark in road openers and DET still trying to find their identity under 2nd yr HC Patricia, we'll call for the visitor to get the job done in this one.

BALTIMORE by 10 over Arizona - Following a 49 pt win against the Dolphins (2★ Newsletter Winner) where QB Jackson threw for 324 yds & 5 TD's (643-200 yd edge), the Ravens (8-3 ATS in home openers) take on a Cardinals squad that erased a 24-6 Q4 deficit in the eventual 27-27 tie (QB Murray 29-54 for 308 yds & 2-1 ratio). From '08-'15 the Cardinals went a perfect 8-0 ATS in road openers with an avg cover of 10 ppg. The past 3 years have seen them suffer both SU & ATS losses with a 20 pt avg margin of defeat. While ARZ has posted just a 5-11 ATS mark against AFC foes, their 2H tenacity a week ago has us cutting the Ravens' lean off at -10.

New England by 20 over MIAMI - After a dominating home effort against the Steelers where they led 30-3 after the 3Q, the Patriots (12-6 ATS vs AFC East foes) head to South Beach to take on a Dolphins team that started their ssn of tanking a week ago against the Ravens (outgained 643-200 in the 59-10 loss). While trips to MIA have proven to be troublesome in recent seasons for the Patriots with outright losses in 5 of the past 6 years including LY's 69 yd miracle TD catch & run, we cannot justify leaning with the Dolphins at any price following LW's no-show in front of their home crowd.

Dallas by 7 over WASHINGTON - While RB Elliott was limited to just 13 carries (53 yds, 1 TD) following his prolonged hold-out a week ago against the Giants, QB Prescott had no issue with rust throwing for 405 yds & 4 TD's in the 35-17 DAL victory. Despite a 380 yd, 3 TD effort from QB Keenum, the Redskins were unable to hold on to a 17-0 lead on the road LW in Philly in the eventual 5 pt defeat. LY's Wk 7 matchup in D.C. against the Cowboys saw WAS snap a 4-gm series losing skid as DAL missed a game-tying 52 yd FG attempt at the end of regulation. With the Cowboys 11-2 ATS against NFC East foes and 9-3 ATS in road openers, we'll call for them to earn the win here against a WAS squad who has covered just 1 of their past 7 home openers.

HOUSTON by 13 over Jacksonville - Following a 14 pt home defeat against the Chiefs where QB Foles was lost in the 1H w/a broken clavicle (rookie QB Minshew 22-25 for 275 yds & 2-1 ratio in relief), the Jaguars head on the road to take on a Texans squad that's on short rest after their MNF meeting in the Superdome against the Saints. In their 2 matchups against the Jaguars a year ago, the Texans held JAX to a total of 10 pts and 378 yds in a pair of victories. With the Jaguars having a Thur matchup at home against the Titans on deck and going just 1-5-1 ATS in recent meetings with the AFC South, the Texans (7-2-1 ATS run) get the lean here.

PITTSBURGH by 7 over Seattle - After a closer than expected 1 pt win LW at home against the Bengals where they had large FD (20-12) and yard (429-233) disadvantages, the Seahawks head on the road for the first time in 2019 (SEA just 1-12-1 ATS in road openers). The Steelers meanwhile were a virtual no-show LW in Foxboro against the Patriots (trailed 30-3 after 3Q). While the Seahawks have gone a solid 7-3-2 ATS vs NDIV foes coming in, their previously mentioned early season road troubles along with PIT's impressive 10-4 ATS run as a HF has us giving them the nod in this one.

San Francisco by 3 over CINCINNATI - While SF & CIN have rich playoff histories (SB matchups in both '81 & '88), both have struggled in recent yrs incl a combined 10-22 mark a ssn ago. Following a 14 pt win LW on the road against TB where they took advantage of 4 TO's, SF remains in the EST for a 2nd consec wk carrying a solid 6-2 ATS mark against AFC foes. The Bengals meanwhile return home following a long trip to the Pacific NW against SEA where they came up just short in 1 pt loss (CIN 20-12 FD & 429-233 yd edges. While CIN has covered 5 straight dating back to LY, SF's 9-3 ATS mark as a NDIV AF has us leaning in their direction for this one.

Kansas City by 14 over OAKLAND - The Raiders are back in the "Black Hole" for a 2nd consec week although they enter this matchup on short rest following a MNF meeting against the Broncos. The Chiefs meanwhile are making their 2nd consec road trip to start the year after a 14 pt win LW in JAX where QB Mahomes was back at it with 378 pass yds & 3 TD's. Over the past 4 years the Chiefs have been nearly perfect against the Raiders as they've won 7 of the 8 matchups with the lone defeat coming on a rainy Thur night in OAK back in '17 (1 pt loss). With the Raiders on just a 4-8 ATS run as of presstime and KC claiming ATS wins in 13 of their L/18 matchups inside of the AFC West, the visitor gets the 2 TD lean here.

LA RAMS by 5 over New Orleans - The schedule makers wasted no time getting these 2 back together after what will go down as one of the most controversial playoff matchups in league history (non-pass interference call not only kept the Saints out of the SB, but also saw the NFL introduce the penalty into part of instant replay challenges). The Saints head West on short rest following a MNF meeting in the Superdome against HOU while the Rams held on to a 3 pt win at CAR. Although revenge is clearly on the side of the visitor following the previously mentioned postssn debacle, it's worth mentioning that the Saints have covered just 2 of their past 9 road openers. With the Rams claiming SU & ATS wins in their home openers in each of the past 4 years (20 pt avg victory), they're certainly worthy of a small lean in this one.

Philadelphia at ATLANTA - SNF - The Eagles overcame a sluggish start to their opener LW against WAS (trailed 17-0 in 2Q) in the 5 pt win (QB Wentz 313 pass yds & 3 TD's). While the Falcons continued their recent struggles as an AD LW at MIN (now 1-7 ATS in that role), they do return to ATL with some confidence as they've covered 13 of their past 15 home openers including 3 outright upsets of PHI in that span ('15, '11 & '05). LY these 2 squared off in the ssn-opening Thur night matchup with the Eagles overcoming a 4Q deficit in the 18-12 victory (ATL 299-232 yd edge). **With both teams expected to be in the mix for postssn appearances this year, call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for the Marquee Winner!**

Cleveland at NY JETS - MNF - It's been nearly 49 years since the Browns and Jets met in the very first MNF contest in league history! The CLE fanbase has to feel all warm and fuzzy in remembering this matchup LY as QB Mayfield came off the bench to lead the come-from-behind 21-17 victory (-3). CLE did however continue their drought of failing to record a Wk 1 victory (last win came in '04) LW thanks to 182 yds in penalties. NY meanwhile blew a 16-0 lead LW at home against the Bills (3★ LP Winner on BUF!). While NY is on a rough overall ATS run at just 4-11-1, CLE is back on MNF for the first time in 5 yrs!
