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# COLLEGE SELECTIONS

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## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ MARSHALL over Fau** - MU is 6-1 SU/4-3 ATS in this series. The dog is 6-1 ATS with B2B outright upsets and the visitor is 5-1 ATS. LY MU got the GW td with :36 left to win 36-31 (+5). FAU has been one of the most affected teams by Covid, having 3 of their 4 games ppd or cancelled including LW's against SMiss. MU has won all 4 games by DD's and are +165 ypg. The Herd's defense is holding foes 80 ypg below their avg (#15 in FBS). Last week Marshall was nearly 2 td chalk and beat LTech 35-17 with the Bulldogs final td coming with just :36 left. FAU QB Tronti only completed 50% against Charlotte 3 weeks ago but did rush for 94 yds. He gets to face a stout Marshall D that has held all 4 foes under 100 rush yds and allow just 69 (2.4) rush ypg. HC Taggart is still getting to know his team and with disjointed practice and possibly missing players we can't help but lean with the favored Thundering Herd to win by more than 3 td's.

**FORECAST: MARSHALL by 24**

**3★ Houston over NAVY** - Houston holds a 3-2 SU/ATS lead vs Navy as AAC foes. LY Hou (+6) was -5 TO's and gave up 447 rush yds (8.0) in a 56-41 loss to end their ssn. Both tms won vs Tulane and lost to BYU, but in those gms Navy was -227 ypg & Hou was +113 ypg. The last 2 wks Navy's option has looked like the usual potent attack as they put up over 250 rush yds in both gms. Hou has stopped the run well this ssn (74 ypg, 2.1 ypc) but in their L/4 gms vs Navy have given up 329 rush ypg (5.4). Hou's pass attack this ssn is led by QB Tune (629, 64%, 4-2) and is avg'g 315 ypg. Navy is allowing 155 pass ypg but they've ply'd 2 option teams and EC didn't have their starting QB last week. Navy's run DEF is struggling as they are all'g 274 ypg (6.1). Navy is 9-2 ATS vs AAC foes the L2Y incl a 3-0 ATS mark this ssn while Hou HC Holgorsen is 0-1 ATS as an AF in AAC play. Navy is improving but they struggled to put away a weak EC team missing their QB and Hou ply'd BYU much closer than the score suggested last week.

**FORECAST: HOUSTON by 21**

**3★ TEXAS OVER Baylor** - This will be the 110th meeting (Tex leads 78-27-4 SU). In LY's game the yds were even at 391 (BU 22-21 FD edge) but Baylor won 24-10 (Tex 1 TO & SOD twice in 2H). BU last played on Oct 3 (game last wk vs Okla St PPD) & only gained 256 yds vs WVU, but were +2 TO's & lost in 2OT, while Tex is off a bye & last lost 53-45 to rival OU in 4OT. Tex DEF has been an issue this ssn as they are allowing 456 ypg & 47 ppg, but BU is only avg'g 304 ypg on OFF & they faced Kansas, who has given up 569 ypg to the other B12 foes they have faced. BU's DEF is only all'g 337 ypg but this the best OFF they will face as QB Ehlinger is hurting teams with his arm (1211, 61%, 16-4) and legs (242, 4.8, 5 td). Tex is just 2-9 ATS as a B12 HF under HC Herman & BU went 6-3 ATS as a B12 AF under HC Rhule, but this is an inexp'd BU team with a new HC & they just had to recently shut their program down (AGAIN) due to covid concerns. Given the rollercoaster BU has been on this ssn, we'll lean Texas here.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Nc State (+) over NORTH CAROLINA** - NCar ended a 3 game series losing streak last year, winning 41-10 (-11). The underdog has owned this series, going 17-5 ATS with 13 outright upsets in the last 22 years and the visitor is 6-1 SU/ATS. NCar trailed 31-7 at half last week but fought back and got within 3 points but had 2 key dropped passes that would have put them in fg range on their final drive. The Heels finished with a 558-432 yd & 27-16 FD edges but had 2 punts blocked, threw a pick-6, was SOD twice inside the FSU25 and missed a fg. NCSt has won 3 straight since Devin Leary took over at QB but last week's 31-20 (-4) win over Duke came at a cost with Leary leaving with a severe ankle inj. Bkp QB Hockman did lead the win over WF in their opener and threw a td pass against Duke in the 4Q. The Heels will be angry off a loss but they are giving DD's to a rival and the underdog has owned this series so we call for NCSt to keep it closer than expected.

**FORECAST: NORTH CAROLINA by 8**

**2★ NORTHWESTERN over Maryland** - NW won the only previous meeting, 37-21 in '17 (-3'). Both teams went 3-9 last year. NW also got a significant upgrade at QB with experienced Indiana transfer Peyton Ramsey while MD only has 10 starters and must replace their entire Dline. The Terps were -221 ypg in B10 play last year, losing by an average of 26 ppg while NW was only -58 and lost by an average of 14 ppg. NW's defense held foes to 23.6 ppg and 64 ypg below their avg. MD allowed 34.7 ppg and 86 ypg above their foes avg. In games where MD was held under 150 rush yds they lost by 47.6 ppg! NW only allowed 137 rush (3.8) and held 9 of their 12 opp's to less than 150 rush yds. The Terps were 2-5 as dogs last year with their avg non-cover in those by 29.1 ppg! NW is 0-6-1 as a HF the L2Y but they were 9-5 as a HF the 2 years prior and they were 25-13 ATS in B10 play from '15-'18.

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY OCTOBER 22ND

**APPALACHIAN ST by 8 over Arkansas St** - In the 4th mtg, all as SBC foes. The last meeting was back in '18 when App St was on the road (-10) and actually trailed 9-7 in the 2Q but scored 28 straight & won 35-9 (+3 TO's). App St has only played 3 gms & has not played in nearly a month (Sept 26th was last gm) due to positive tests, as they have had 2 gms PPD to later in the season. Ark St just played last Thur vs GSt and won 59-52 (Won Thur Night marquee on Ark St last wk!). Ark St's DEF still is having issues stopping anyone (allowing 482 ypg & 40 ppg) and just gave up 583 yds to GSt. App St does have a potent OFF when everyone is 100% led by QB Thomas & RB Harrington (301, 5.1, 6 td). App St DEF has only all'd 323 ypg & 19 ppg, but face an Ark St offense putting up 496 ypg (384 pass ypg) incl 609 yds (551 pass) vs GSt and the App St DEF could be rusty given all the interruptions. App St was 6-3 ATS LY vs SBC foes, but Ark St is 2-0 ATS as an SBC dog under HC Anderson. Call 1-800-654-3448 to get our Thurs Night Marquee for \$12!

### FRIDAY OCTOBER 23TH

**Tulsa by 14 over USF** - As conference foes Tulsa is 0-3 SU vs USF, but have won the L/2 games ATS. Despite putting up 37 pts, USF only gained 324 yds last wk vs Temple (4 scoring drives under 50 yds) & for the ssn are putting up just 311 ypg vs FBS foes. Tulsa was supposed to play last week but their game vs Cincy was PPD due to covid issues w/ the Bearcats. Tulsa's last game was back on Oct 3 at UCF where they came back from a 16-0 1H deficit and snapped UCF's 21-gm home win streak. Tulsa's DEF was good vs Okla St (277 yds all'd, but faced bkp frosh QB after 1Q) and "held" UCF to 455 yds, which is 242 ypg below their ssn avg! USF's DEF is holding AAC foes to 392 ypg, but have given up 37 ppg (USF -4 TO's in AAC play). USF was just 1-4 ATS LY as a DD underdog and Tulsa was 2-0 ATS LY as an AAC road favorite, but USF is off a normal week while Tulsa had another game PPD due to covid issues.

**UAB by 5 over Louisiana** - This will be the 7th meeting, but first since 2002 when LA hosted UAB and won 34-0. LA is 0-3 SU all-time at UAB. We used UAB as a 3★ on these pages then upgraded them to our top 4★ LPS on Sat in their win over WKU. We also won our Wed night Marquee going against LA in their loss to Coastal Carolina last week. Taking out their game vs Miami, UAB's OFF is putting up 434 ypg & 36 ppg & their DEF is giving up just 285 ypg & 18 ppg in their other 4 gms. LA's rush offense ran well vs CCar (240 yds, 7.7 ypc) & for the season LA's OLine has done well in the run & pass game, paving the way for 187 ypg (5.7) and all'g just 4 sks on 115 pass att (3.5%). LA's DEF has not been the same as LY's squad, giving up 427 ypg the L/3 gms & face RB Brown who has 472 rush yds (4.8, 6 td) this ssn. LA comes in as a great underdog under HC Napier, going 8-3-1 ATS in that role. Napier is also 5-1 ATS the L2Y vs non-conf foes. However UAB comes in with an excellent home record, going 21-0 SU and 15-4-2 ATS since returning in 2017.

# COLLEGE MARQUEES

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**WISCONSIN by 28 over Illinois** - Major revenge game here for Wisconsin who were looking ahead to OSU and lost so 30 point chalk last year! The Badgers only have Nebraska on deck so no need to look ahead this time. Wisc held a +105 yard edge in that loss. The Illini have lost 7 straight in Camp Randall by 19 ppg and the last 2 losses were by 29 & 45 points. Wisc has 14 starters back and were +71 ypg vs B10 foes. UI returns 14 starters but were -150 ypg vs B10 foes. HC Lovie Smith added a large group of transfers but 3 didn't make it to the opener. The Badgers may be w/o QB Jack Coan but highly recruited rFr Graham Mertz may actually be an upgrade. Illinois was one of the luckiest teams in the country last year and Wisc has won their L/3 ssn openers by 43 ppg (all vs FBS foes) so we've got the Badgers getting sweet revenge by 4 td's.

### SATURDAY OCTOBER 24TH

**BOSTON COLLEGE by 7 over Georgia Tech** - BC has won 3 straight meetings and they last met in '16's opener which took place in Ireland. Both teams enter off a loss. GT was overmatched last week in their 73-7 (+27) loss vs Clemson. The game was essentially over at halftime, trailing 49-7 and getting outgained 473-104. BC lost 33-14 (+12) at VT. QB Jurkovec had his 3rd straight 300 yard passing game but BC was also held under 100 rush yds for the 5th straight game! The Eagles had trouble stopping the QB run, allowing QB Hooker to rush for 164 (9.1) and now they face QB Sims who is also mobile. Jurkovec might have his best game yet against a pass D that allows 308 ypg. BC has the edge in all 3 phases including big edge on defense, holding foes 59 ypg below their avg. The Eagles are 0-4 as a HF but we think they will bounce back off the loss and win by a td.

**LOUISVILLE by 3 over Florida St** - FSU has won 2 straight in this series but UL is 3-1 ATS and the home team is 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS. FSU QB Jordan Travis gets to face his old team. The 'Noles QB led an upset win over N Carolina last week, rushing for 107 and throwing for 191 though he did only complete 42%. FSU led 31-7 at half but only finished with 52 yards and 5 FD's in the 2H. UL enters on a 4 game losing streak but they did stay close vs ND, losing 12-7 (+16'). The Cardinals were held under 100 rush yds for just the 2nd time under Satterfield and were outgained 338-219. FSU is allowing 475 ypg and 3 of their 4 ACC foes topped 500 yds. UL is only allowing 379 ypg and are holding foes 8 ypg below their avg. The Cardinals have been held under 300 yds in 2 of their L/3 but FSU allows foes to put up 96 ypg above their avg so we think UL gets right and wins but we have a slight lean with the underdog.

**Notre Dame by 3 over PITTSBURGH** - ND is 5-1 SU in this series but Pitt often keeps it closer than expected, going 4-1 ATS and 5 of the L/6 mtgs are decided by 7 pts or less. The visitor is on an 8-2-1 ATS run. QB Pickett was a late scratch for Pitt last week (ankle). Ariz St transfer Joey Yellen started in his place and threw for 277 but only compl'd 47% and Pitt settled for 4 fg's in the red zone. ND was 16' pt chalk last week but only beat Lville 12-7. The Irish did finish with a 338-219 yd edge. RB Williams has topped 100 yds in 3 of their F/4 but Pitt's vaunted Dline only allows 62 (1.9) rush ypg and the Panthers already have 24 sacks! ND is avg 261 (7.5) rush ypg and have only allowed 7 sacks but 4 of those came last week. Narduzzi does his best work as an underdog, going 16-8 as an ACC dog with 8 outright upsets. If Pickett played last week they easily could have won that game and he could return here so we will call for Pitt to keep this very close.

**Alabama by 24 over TENNESSEE** - Bama has won 13 straight over their rivals and are on a 10-4 ATS run. The Vols are just 1-8 ATS at home in this series. Last year Tenn was about to get within a td in the 4Q when QB Guarantano fumbled on the goal line and Bama ret'd it for a td. Last week the Tide put up 564 yds against UGA's vaunted defense that held the Vols to 214 yds the week prior. QB Jones is completing 78% with a 12-2 ratio and Bama is avg 184 ypg more than their foes allow (#3 in FBS). The Vols are once again having issues at QB after Guarantano threw 2 pick-6's in the 1H vs KY and Tenn lost 34-7 (-6). Tenn is -33 ypg on the season and their offense avg 50 ypg less than foes allow (#109). The Vols had been on a roll until the last 2 weeks and their defense is still playing well. Bama is off their biggest game of the season and perhaps highly touted true frosh Harrison Bailey will give the Vols a spark. Bama still wins by more than 3 td's.

**Virginia Tech by 14 over WAKE FOREST** - VTech is 6-1 SU and covered 5 of the last 6 mtgs. LY the underdog Hokies trailed 10-6 at half despite a 229-137 yd edge then got rolling in the 2H & won by 19. QB Hooker got the start last week and had 164 of VT's 350 rush yds. RB Herbert has topped 100 in all 4 games and averages nearly 10 ypc!!! WF never trailed last week and beat Virginia 40-23 (+2). The Deacons were +61 yds but -9 FD's and did have a 3 TO edge. The Hokies are 7-2 SU/ATS when Hendon Hooker starts at QB and their defense is getting healthier after missing multiple starters early in the season. WF is allowing 198 (4.6) rush ypg while VT is avg 312 (6.9). Clawson is only 3-6 ATS in games following an outright upset so we call for the Hokies to win by a touchdown.

**CLEMSON by 42 over Syracuse** - In '17 Cuse handed Clemson their only loss. In '18 Cuse came within a 4th down stop of once again beating the Tigers. Last year Clemson didn't mess around, beating Cuse 41-6 (-27), although it was only 17-6 at half. This time Cuse appears to be completely overmatched. The Orange were +3 last week but without key starters including AA DB Cisco and were overmatched by Liberty in a 38-20 loss, outgained 520-308. Clemson was nearly 4 td chalk last week vs GTech but had no trouble covering that, leading 52-7 at half and poured it on in the 2H, winning 73-7. Clearly Clemson is head over shoulders better than Cuse, but with this being a home game, they will be able to play walk-ons that don't travel to road games so the backups in the 2H will be far less effective than last week. In last year's win over Charlotte they played 110 players and won by 42. We think this game could be similar.

**COASTAL CAROLINA by 9 over Georgia Southern** - GS has won 5 of the 6 mtgs SU, including the L2Y. LY GS (-6') hosted CCar and despite having a 360-228 yd edge it took 3OT to get the 30-27 win. CCar is off a win at ranked LA last Wed & are now 4-0 this ssn (3-0 ATS vs FBS foes), while GS just played UMass last wk (41-0 win) & despite being 3-1 have had a more turbulent season. CCar's OFF has put up 434 ypg & 41 ppg this ssn incl 202 rush ypg (4.6) & their OL has all'd just 2 sks in 88 pass att! rFr QB McCall has taken command of the OFF with 930 pass yds (68%, 11-1) & 184 rush yds (4.4). GS's option attack has put up 280 ypg (5.9) vs FBS foes, and their DEF last wk held UMass to 191 yds & 0 pts, but did allow ULM to gain 167 yds above their ssn avg earlier this ssn. CCar is 0-3 ATS under HC Chadwell as home SBC chalk, but GS was 0-2 ATS LY as a single-digit SBC dog LY. Given that CCar has been more consistent this season we'll lean with them even off a big win.

**MIAMI, FL by 16 over Virginia** - UM is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS in this series and won 17-9 (-2) last year. Virginia played WF closer than the final score appeared last week, losing 40-23, but were +9 FD's and were tied early 4Q. UM beat Pitt 31-19 (-13) last week but yards were nearly even and Pitt was even playing with their backup QB. D'Eriq King only completed 52% and threw for 222 with 4-2 ratio but was without their leading receiver TE Jordan (inj). They could be facing another backup QB here as Virginia ply'd w/o QB Armstrong last week, bkp QB Stone only threw for 193 and 2 int's. Virginia has lost 3 straight games by 17, 17 & 18 points. Only one of those opponents were on Miami's level (Clemson) and the opening Vegas line is only 11 so clearly our lean is with the home Hurricanes.

**UCF by 17 over Tulane** - As AAC foes Tulane holds a 3-1 ATS record. Tulane gave up 581 yds to SMU last Fri but only lost by 3 pts in OT while UCF put up 798 yds incl 601 pass yds in a 50-49 loss at Mem (missed FG w/ 19 sec left). Tulane's pass DEF will have their hands full vs QB Gabriel (1756, 65%, 14-2) and a UCF OFF putting up 232 ypg more than what their foes allow (#1 FBS!). However the UCF DEF has been the opposite of the OFF as they are allowing 124 ypg more than what their foes avg (#127 FBS) and last wk gave up 703 yds! Tulane does have frosh QB Pratt starting (475, 43%) but despite losing RB Spears (OFY inj) Tulane is avg'g 233 rush ypg led by RB's Huderson (312, 7.1) & Carroll (297, 5.0, 7 td) & UCF's run DEF is not very good (213 ypg, 4.6). UCF is on a 2-9 ATS slide vs AAC foes & are just 1-4 ATS the L2Y as an AAC DF, but Tulane is just 2-5 ATS the L3Y as an AD in AAC play. We'll lean with the stronger OFF at home off 2 straight losses.

**Penn St by 9 over INDIANA** - Last year Indiana came in on a 4 game win streak and ranked for the first time since 1994. The Hoosiers were nearly 2 td dogs but only lost 34-27 and finished with a 462-371 yd edge. PSU returns 12 starters but did suffer a huge loss when LB Micah Parsons opted out. Indiana has 17 starters back from a team that won 8 games last year. HC Allen is only 2-7 as a HD while PSU is on a 10-4 run as an AF but this is the Hoosiers best team under Allen. IU was +81 ypg last year while PSU was +65 ypg. The Hoosiers defense only allowed 24.4 ppg last year and held PSU 32 yds below their avg and they've got 9 starters back. Penn St is a National Title contender and while we like Indiana's team this year, we think the Nittany Lions are more than a td better than the Hoosiers.

**MICHIGAN ST by 17 over Rutgers** - MSU has won the last 6 meetings (4-2 ATS) including LY when the Spartans posted their first shutout since '16, winning 27-0 (-21). New HC Mel Tucker is in a tough spot, hired after LY's signing day, and he's got an inexperienced squad with just 9 starters back that didn't have a spring. Greg Schiano takes over for a 2nd tenure at Rutgers. In his first tenure he only went 3-20 in his first 2 years. The Scarlet Knights have lost 21 straight Big 10 games. Rutgers does have 14 starters back but last year's squad was -161 ypg on the season and -224 ypg on the road. Mich St was +50 ypg on the season and +132 at home. Both coaches are in a tough spot but Tucker has a much more experienced squad so we lean with the chalk.

**OHIO ST by 24 over Nebraska** - OSU has won 5 straight meetings with 4 coming by 25 points or more while LTH was '18 and Neb nearly upset OSU as 18 pt dogs, losing 36-31. Last year the Huskers got blown out at home 48-7 as 17 pt dogs. OSU only returns 10 starters but 1 of those is Heisman contender QB Justin Fields and no significant opt outs. Neb has 15 starters back including 10 on offense while the defense gets 5 of their top 6 tk'lrs back. Neb was +20 ypg in B10 play last year while OSU +274. HC Frost wasn't happy to see this as his opener but he should be comforted to know that OSU has Penn State on deck. HC Day went 5-2 as a HF and we think the Buckeyes will win easily but the Huskers keep it within 4 tds.

**Iowa by 7 over PURDUE** - Iowa is 10-4 SU/8-6 ATS in the series. The Hawkeyes have covered 5 straight in Purdue. Iowa was nearly 3 td chalk last year but only won 26-20. Purdue returns 17 starters including WR Rondale Moore who opted back in. The Boilermakers should be significantly improved on defense with 11 of their top 13 tk'lrs back. Iowa returns 12 starters but must replace QB Stanley and they only have 5 starters back on defense. Brohm is 6-3 as a HD and Purdue has the experience edge but Iowa is 16-4 as an AF and they've owned this series when playing on the road so we have the Hawkeyes winning by just under a td.

**SMU by 4 over Cincinnati** - As AAC foes Cincy is 3-1 SU and in their last mtg ('18) SMU forced 3 TO's & took the game into OT but lost on a pick-6 (Cincy 477-351 yd edge & 25-13 FD edge). Cincy's game last wk at Tulsa was PPD (covid issues for Cincy) and the status of who is on/out this week is unknown. SMU is off another close win, this time vs Tulane in OT 30-27. Cincy last played on Oct 3rd vs USF and held the Bulls to 291 yds in a 28-7 win. Cincy's OFF is averaging just 332 yds and 26 pts against FBS foes this year but their DEF is holding FBS foes to only 284 ypg & 9 ppg. SMU's OFF is running nicely as they are putting up 563 ypg & are gaining 88 more ypg than what their foes typically allow. SMU is led by QB Buechele who has 1710 pass yds this ssn (67%, 12-2) which is #2 FBS! SMU's DEF is solid (holding foes to 13 ypg below their ssn avg) but they can get after the QB (12 sks in L/3 games) but face a Cincy OL that has all'd just 4 sks in 3 gms. SMU is 3-1 ATS as an AAC HD under HC Dykes & while Cincy was just 2-4 ATS LY as AAC chalk under HC Fickell as an AD, this is their 1st road gm of the ssn & their 1st gm in 3 weeks.

**Oklahoma by 9 over TCU** - OU leads the all-time series 15-5 SU, and since '16 the Sooners are 5-0 SU & 4-1 ATS against TCU. LY despite outgaining TCU by over 300 yds (511-204) & having a huge FD edge (30-11) OU only won the game 28-24 (TCU had pick 6). Both teams are off a bye & have each lost to ISU and KSt & went a comb'd 0-3-1 ATS in those gms. OU's OFF has not taken much of a dip despite having rFR QB Rattler ('1186, 71%, 13-5) starting as they are gaining 80 more ypg than what their foes allow coming in. OU does face a TCU DEF that has held foes to 79 ypg below their season avg. OU's DEF gave up over 100 rush yds to Tex QB Ehlinger & TCU's QB Duggan is their #1 rusher & is hitting 68% of his passes (OU all'g 301 pass ypg vs B12 tms). OU is just 4-8-1 ATS as away chalk under HC Riley, but TCU is just 6-14-1 ATS the L3Y vs B12 foes. These 2 teams have had all of their B12 games decided by single digits & we see this being a close contest.

**MISSISSIPPI by 1 over Auburn** - Aub is 16-4 SU in this series and 8-3 ATS when playing in Oxford. The visitor is 6-0 ATS. The Tigers were nearly 3 td chalk last year and dominated the stats last year, finishing with a 507-266 yd edge but had 3 missed fg's and were -2 TO's and only won 20-14. Ole Miss spent all their energy trying to upset Bama 2 wks ago and fell behind 20-0 at half vs Ark. The Rebels had a +48 yd edge but had 7 TO's including 6 int's (2 pick 6's) and a goal-line fumble by QB Corral. We went against Aub last week as our Underdog POW, calling for SCar to pull the upset and also used it as a 3★ LPS and the Tigers lost 30-22 (-3). QB Nix completed just 51% and threw 3 int's. Aub is -23 ypg and their defense is allowing 27 ypg more than their foes avg. Ole Miss is avg 540 ypg and while their defense has been awful, they did look improved last week. Bo Nix hits 62% w/an 11-0 ratio at home but just 51% and 10-10 on the road. Aub is 3-5 SU in those games so we call for the Rebels to pull the upset.

**West Virginia by 6 over TEXAS TECH** - Before LY WVU had won the L/5 games SU & had won 3 straight ATS, but in '19 WVU had 2 early TO's and TTech went up 35-10 in the 2Q in a 38-17 win (WVU yd edge 549-481, but -4 TO's). TTech comes in off bye and are just 1-3 SU/ATS and are making the switch to QB Colombi (359, 74%, 3-1) who played in HC Wells system at Utah St. WVU held Kan to 157 yds & 7 FD's in a 38-17 win. TTech does face a tough WVU DEF that has only all'd 252 ypg in 3 Big 12 gms. On the other hand WVU's OFF has got going last week vs Kansas (544 yds, 29-7 FD edge). The Mountaineers led 38-10 late 4Q but gave up a KR td which gave Kansas a backdoor cover and cost us our top play on these pages. WVU could keep rolling against a TTech DEF that has all'd 465 ypg & 42 ypg vs Big 12 foes & are all'g conf foes to gain 53 yds above their ssn avg. TTech is 3-1 ATS under Wells as a HD, while WVU is 1-0 ATS as an AF under HC Brown. We'll give a slight lean to WVU as they have the better DEF and 1 stop could be the difference here.

**MEMPHIS by 17 over Temple** - Temple has been the dog in all 5 AAC matchups, but have gone 5-0 ATS and have pulled the outright upset 3 times incl LY when Temple forced 4 TO's (scored 16 pts of TO's) and won 30-28, so Memphis is out for revenge. Temple is off a close 39-37 home win vs USF while Memphis snapped their 13-gm losing streak to UCF, winning 50-49. Temple will have their hands full vs a Memphis OFF that is avg 597 ypg & are gaining 158 ypg more than what their foes allow! The Owls pass D will also get tested vs QB White who has 1141 pass yds (69%, 13-3) in 3 gms. However Memphis cannot stop the pass as they are all'g 458 ypg and last wk vs UCF gave up 601 pass yds! While Temple doesn't have the pass OFF UCF does, QB Russo (476, 71%, 5-3) is a veteran & has 2 All-Conf WR's to throw to. Despite all'g 34 ppg the Temple DEF is giving up just 312 ypg but this is their toughest test yet. Memphis is 9-3 ATS the L3Y as home AAC chalk and while their DEF will give up points we feel their OFF is strong enough to get them the W.

**KANSAS ST by 27 over Kansas** - 118th Sunflower Showdown. KU actually leads the series 65-47-5 SU but since 2009 KSt has won 11 straight SU & gone 8-3 ATS. KSt comes off a bye week, while KU played at WVU last week & was outgained 544-157, out FD'd 29-7 and trailed 38-10 late 4Q then got a KR td for the backdoor cover, costing us a 4★ both on these pages and a LPS. Though KSt is 3-0 SU/ATS in Big 12 play they will be w/o QB Thompson (OFY w/ injury) and true frosh Will Howard will be under center. This ssn he is just 16/32 for 314 yds in limited action, but KSt could rely on RB Howard (248, 5.0) going against a KU run DEF that is all'g 241 ypg (5.1) vs Big 12 foes. In 4 gms KSt's DEF has gotten to the QB 10 times and faces a KU OLine that has given up 16 sks in 4 gms. KSt's DEF has given up 455 ypg, but are forcing TO's (7 in 4 gms) and are facing a weak KU offense. KSt HC Klieman is 9-3 ATS vs Big 12 foes while KU is just 2-5 ATS in their L/7 gms vs Big 12 tms & barely covered last week.

**LSU by 11 over South Carolina** - LSU is 18-2-1 SU in this series with 6 straight wins. The visitor is 4-1 ATS. They last met in '15, LSU won 45-21 (-19). We picked up our 2nd Underdog outright upset winner as well as a 3★ LPS last week with SC beating Aub 30-22 (+3). LSU had their game cancelled vs Florida last week. LSU has been DD chalk in all 3 games this year but have been upset in 2 of those. SC was 0-2 but they've won B2B and cooled Muschamp's hotseat somewhat. LSU has a big edge on offense avg 467 ypg while SC only avg 365. The Gamecocks defense is allowing 13 ypg more than their foes avg. LSU's defense has certainly struggled, allowing 495 ypg but they've got plenty of talent and prior to their cancelled game DC Peline said he was going to simplify the defense to lessen their frequent blown coverages. Had LSU played last week they wouldn't have had QB Brennan who has an injury to his throwing shoulder (check status). If he is good to go, and with extra time to focus on the changes and LSU going from DD chalk to laying less than a td we feel much more comfortable with the Tigers.

**SOUTH ALABAMA by 13 over ULM** - ULM holds a 4-2 SU series lead vs SAla. In LY's meeting ULM (-15) led 30-10 in the 4Q until SAla got a late TD to secure the backdoor cover. ULM is off a bye, while SAla faced TXSt (won 30-20). In their L/4 meetings ULM's OFF has put up 481 ypg & 33 ppg against SAla & while the Jags DEF is playing alright (415 ypg & 28 ppg all'd) the ULM offense has been held to 200 or fewer yds & 7 or fewer pts in 3 of their 5 gms. The lone bright spot for ULM has been QB Suits (1121, 60%, 6-4) & faces a SAla pass DEF all'g 275 ypg. SAla has not been able to run the ball well this ssn (131, 3.7) but could find success to balance their pass attack (280 pass ypg) as ULM's run DEF is giving up 262 ypg (5.4) this year. SAla did go 6-2 ATS LY vs SBC foes, but all 8 gms were as a dog & HC Campbell is 2-0 ATS as SBC chalk. We feel confident in leaning with SAla as ULM is just 7-14 ATS the L3Y as an underdog.

## Iowa St +3' over OKLAHOMA ST

**Iowa St over OKLAHOMA ST** - Since '12 ISU has won just 1 mtg SU (48-42 in 2018) and the home team has lost the L/4 meetings ATS. ISU is off a bye week & last beat TTech 2 wks ago, while OSU has not played since Oct 3rd (game last wk PPD vs Baylor) and in that game beat Kan 47-7 (593-193 yd edge). ISU QB Purdy got going last gm (302, 2 td) & RB Hall has ran for 531 yds (5.7, 8 td) in 4 gms this ssn, but faces an OSU DEF that is holding foes to 149 ypg below their season avg. After giving up over 400 yds in their F/2 B12 gms, ISU held TTech to 270 yds & 15 pts and are holding teams to 98 rush ypg (2.9). OSU's OFF relied on its run game the L/2 gms (249 ypg, 4.9) and could get QB Sanders back here, though frosh QB Illingworth (478, 74%, 3-1) has played well. ISU HC Campbell is 16-6 ATS as a Big 12 dog overall & is 8-3 as a B12 road dog. While OSU is 4-1 ATS the L2Y as a B12 HF, it has been a couple weeks since OSU's last game & we like Campbell in an underdog role.

**BYU by 34 over Texas St** - First meeting. BYU is off a game last Fri at Hou while TXSt lost at SAla last week & now is playing their 5th straight road game! TXSt's pass DEF has given up over 300 yds 3 times (allowing 286 ypg & 71% completions!) and faces a BYU passing attack led by QB Zach Wilson (1641, 78%, 12-1) that is putting up 354 ypg. Despite being w/o some OL starters this ssn, BYU has only all'd 4 sks on 148 pass att (2.7%). Since putting up 429 ypg & 37 ppg the F/3 gms, TXSt's OFF is only putting up 320 ypg & 19 ppg and has to face a BYU defense that was tested last week (all'd 438 yds) has allowed just 288 ypg and 14 ppg this ssn. TXSt's OL has been an issue at times (16 sks all'd) and faces a BYU defense that has collected 16 sks in 5 gms. BYU & TXSt both faced Troy this ssn & BYU held them to 181 yds & 7 pts while TXSt gave up 488 yds & 37 pts. With this game being in the middle of their SBC schedule, TXSt may pack it in early if they get down. TXSt is just 3-6 ATS as an AD under Spavital and BYU is 4-1 ATS this ssn as chalk.

**COLORADO ST by 17 over New Mexico** - 68th meeting. CSU holds a 42-25 SU lead all-time, and since 2010 the Rams are 10-0 SU & 8-2 ATS vs the Lobos. LY CSU (-3) only led NMex 28-21 in the 4Q, but got a TD to pull ahead by 14 pts & then forced 2 late TO's to get the 35-21 win (551-345). CSU hired former BC HC Addazio to be the new coach, while NMex brought in Ariz St DC Gonzales to be the new head man. CSU has QB O'Brien back (2803, 62%, 13-7) along with a talented set of receivers, though WR Jackson (77 rec, 1119 yds, 8 td LY) opted out & an improved DEF from LY brings back 8 st'rs. NMex has just 4 ret st'rs on DEF (do have former HC Rocky Long as DC) and could struggle with CSU's pass attack (#128 pass DEF LY), but they do return 8 OFF st'rs incl QB Tuoti. No fans will be here, so there's no crowd edge but CSU was 2-0 ATS LY as MW chalk and we see CSU as the more talented team and has a "new" veteran HC. We'll lean with the Rams here as NMex is just 4-12 ATS the L2Y in MW play. NMex did have to pause team activities last wk due to positive covid tests, so there's a chance this game could be PPD.

**BOISE ST by 20 over Utah St** - Boise State leads the series 19-5 SU & more recently have won the last 3 games both SU and ATS. LY Boise (-9) was tied with Utah St 7-7 in 1Q, but then scored 49 straight points incl a punt return TD & a pick-six and won 56-21. Boise brings back 5 st'rs on OFF incl soph QB Bachmeier & RB Holani, but return just 1 starter to the OL. Boise's DEF gave up 346 ypg & 22 ppg LY and brings back 6 st'rs from that unit. USU lost a big-time player in QB Jordan Love (1st rd draft pick), as well as their top rusher & top WR but returns 7 OFF st'rs incl 4 on the OL. The new USU QB will likely be former Utah QB Jason Shelly. The Aggie DEF did all'd 441 ypg & 31 ppg last ssn, and 5 st'rs are back. Boise had a reputation of not being a great HF, but last year vs MW foes was 4-1 ATS as home chalk and USU is just 1-3 ATS the L2Y as a road dog in MW play. Both teams have exp'd HC's that will have their team prepared, but Boise looks to have the edge in overall talent on both sides of the ball & we like them here by nearly 3 td's.

**FRESNO ST by 3 over Hawaii** - Fresno holds a 29-22-1 SU lead & since '11 have gone 8-1 SU/6-2-1 ATS. LY Fresno (+2) travelled to Hawaii & trailed 24-14 at HT, but responded with 24 straight pts & ended up getting the GW FG as time expired. Both teams have new HC's as Kalen DeBoer takes over at Fresno while Todd Graham has his 5th different HC job. UH loses QB McDonald (4135, 64%, 33-14) & a trio of WR's that each topped 900 yds LY, but starting QB Cordeiro has experience. UH's DEF has just 5 st'rs back from a unit that gave up 431 ypg & 32 ppg. Fresno will also need to replace their QB & that could be Jake Haener (Wash transfer) and the Bulldogs have their top rusher back in RB Rivers (899, 5.1, 13 td) but did lose their top tk'r LB Rice (transfer to Ark St) but still have 6 DEF st'rs back. Fresno was just 1-4 ATS as a HF last ssn, while UH went just 1-3 as a MW underdog LY. These 2 teams look to be evenly matched on paper & we'll call for the home squad by a FG.

**SAN DIEGO ST by 14 over Unlv** - 30th meeting. SDSt holds a 20-9 SU lead, but the past 2 games have been close contests. In '18 SDSt was 24-pt chalk but gave up a late TD run & were upset 27-24 & LY SDSt (-12) was outgained by UNLV, but won 20-17 after a late UNLV missed FG. SDSt has a "new" HC in Brady Hoke (was HC here '09-'10) and they return 6 OFF st'rs, but will need to find a new QB & will need a bounce back year from their run gm (141 ypg, 3.4 ypc). The Aztec DEF was dominant last ssn (288 ypg & 12.7 ppg all'd) and held foes to 118 ypg below their ssn avg and bring back 8 st'rs from that unit! UNLV has a new HC in Marcus Arroyo (Oregon OC) and he gets back 8 st'rs on the UNLV OFF incl QB Oblad & RB Williams (1257 yds, 5.9 ypc, 11 td). The UNLV DEF all'd 71 more ypg than what their foes avg'd LY and that unit loses 7 st'rs incl the top 3 tk'lrs. SDSt comes in just 1-5 ATS the L2Y as MW chalk at home, but UNLV was just 2-6 the L2Y as an AD in MW play & had no spring practice, while SDSt was able to get 6 practices in this spring.

**SAN JOSE ST by 6 over Air Force** - As MW foes AF is 3-0 SU, but have lost the L/2 meetings ATS. LY AF (-19) hosted SJSt and only led 21-10 at HT, but pulled away to lead 41-10 before 2 late SJSt TD's made the final 41-24. In that game SJSt gave up 382 rush yds to AF. AF has already played 1 time this season, as they beat Navy 40-7 (410-241 yd edge) despite missing several key players on both sides of the ball. On their updated '20 roster AF lists just 61 players which means depth will be a concern! SJSt returns 13 st'rs, but loses their QB Love (3923, 61%, 22-8) but bring in grad transfer QB Starkel from Ark & they have a trio of talented WR's back. The SJSt OFF LY put up 42 more ypg than what their foes allowed for the ssn. SJSt also returns 7 st'rs to a DEF that allowed 70 more ypg than what their foes avg'd LY. SJSt was 4-2 ATS LY as a MW dog & AF is just 4-9 ATS as an away favorite vs MW foes since 2014. SJSt has been prepping for the option since the schedules were announced & at home (no fans) they can keep this one close.

**Wyoming by 4 over NEVADA** - Just the 9th all-time meeting, and 5th as MW foes. Wyoming has the edge in the series as Mountain-West foes, going 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS. Last year Wyo (-14) put up 479 yds on Nev incl 258 rush (5.9) and won easily 31-3 (held Nev to 335 yds). Wyo has turned into a run-first team & this ssn have the personnel to be great on the ground, as they return their starting

Wyoming lost 2 LB's the NFL (3rd & 6th rd picks), but have 5 st'rs back and their DEF should remain solid. Nev brings back talent on OFF with 9 st'rs incl QB Strong, RB Tava, their top 2 WR's and 4 OL. The Wolfpack DEF returns 7 st'rs incl star DT Peterson (9 sk, 6 fl LY). Wyo is 6-1 ATS the L2Y as MW chalk, but Nevada is 5-2 ATS under Norvell as a home dog. This should be a close game as these two squads appear evenly matched.

**LIBERTY by 14 over Southern Miss** - First meeting. Lib enters 5-0 after they won as 3' pt road chalk over P5 foe Syracuse. Lib finished with a +212 yd edge and the Flames finished with 338 (7.0) rushing. Lib played w/o leading rusher Mack but both RB's Pickett (115) and Louis (170) topped 100. SM had their game vs UTEP cancelled due last week due to Covid. SM is -89 ypg on the year and have struggled on both offense, avg 66 ypg less than their foes allow (#116), and defense, allowing 73 ypg more than their foes avg (#124). The Flames are avg 60 ypg more than their foes allow (#19 in FBS) and hold foes 19 ypg below their avg (#33 in FBS). Lib already owns 2 wins over CUSA foes, finishing +196 & +223 yds in those 2 games. We can't go against the Flames again.

**MINNESOTA by 3 over Michigan** - Mich is 22-2 SU in this series and on a 12-4 ATS run. They last met in '17 and Mich finished with a 427-164 yd edge, winning 33-10 (-15). The Wolverines have 10 starters returning and will break in a new QB in Joe Milton. Minn has 13 starters back after AA WR Bateman opted back in. The Gophers have a big edge at QB with Tanner Morgan (3253, 66%, 30-7). Mich has the edge on defense with 5 of their top 8 tk'lrs back but they did suffer a big loss when Thorpe candidate CB Ambry Thomas opted out. Minn lost 6 of their top 8 tk'lrs from last year. Minn was +134 ypg in B10 play LY while Mich was +89. The Gophers are 10-5 as a HD and we'll call for them to pull the upset.

**TROY by 7 over Georgia St** - As SBC foes, Troy is 5-2 SU (just 3-4 ATS) and in their meeting a year ago GS ran all over Troy (390 yds, 6.8) and never trailed in a 52-33 win. GSt gets a couple of extra days of rest after their game vs Ark St last Thur where they lost 59-52 (gave up 609 yds!) while Troy faced FCS EKU and needed a last-sec FG to win. Despite having a new QB, soph Watson is playing well thus far as he has 1081 yds pass yds (69%, 9-3) and Troy has several talented WR's. GSt did allow just 292 yds vs ECar, but in their 2 SBC games have all'd 564 ypg & 47 ppg incl giving up 551 pass yds to Ark St last wk! Troy has only all'd 3.5 ypc (124 rush ypg) this ssn, but will have their hands full vs a GSt rush attack gaining 246 ypg (5.4) & rFr QB Brown threw for 314 yds last wk. We have a little more faith in Troy as GSt is just 2-7-3 ATS the L3Y as an away dog.

**CHARLOTTE by 10 over UTEP** - Charlotte won only prior meeting last year 28-21 (-12). Both teams had their games cancelled last week. UTEP has played much better defense this year, holding foes to 326 ypg and 10 ypg below their average. They've held their last 2 opponents to 210 & 193. UC averages 427 ypg and the 49ers defense did hold the high powered NTx offense to a ssn low 479 two weeks ago. The Miners did catch LA Tech when they were missing multiple starting OLine and QB Hardison is only hitting 52%. UC is allowing just 56% completions. This is a long trip to the east coast but Dimel has UTEP on the right track and UTEP has actually covered 3 straight when playing in the ETZ.

**RICE by 1 over Middle Tennessee** - MT is out for revenge after losing as 2 td home chalk last year. We can't remember a single time we've seen a team have a 6 game-under-belt edge like MT has here. Rice won their last 3 games of last season but this is their first game. The Owls have 17 starters returning. MT led NTexas 28-14 last week then collapsed and lost 52-35 (-6). The Blue Raiders allowed 768 yds including 462 (9.4) on the ground. Rice HC Bloomgren likes to run a more physical offense coming from the Stanford tree but they did only avg 128 (3.6) rush ypg LY. Middle Tenn is allowing 256 (5.6) rush ypg. Middle Tennessee has looked pretty and Rice is playing their first game.

**UTSA by 3 over Louisiana Tech** - LT has won 6 straight series meetings but UTSA did cover last year, only losing 41-27 as 20' pt dogs. UTSA had a tough matchup last week against Army and lost 28-16 (+8) and we picked up a 3★ LP Totals winner on UNDER 49.5. LT nearly got within a td before the half last week vs Marshall but was SOD at the LT1 then allowed td's on 3 straight poss in the 2H & lost 35-17. The Bulldogs were outgained 402-267. UTSA has lost 3 straight but did play both BYU & UAB closer than expected. The RoadRunners are avg 30 ypg more than their foes allow. LT has been held under 300 yds in B2B games and avg 67 ypg less than their foes allow. The Bulldogs Oline has been banged up and UTSA does have 13 sacks this year. UTSA is 5-14 ATS at home but they've played much closer in their losses than LT has and they both faced BYU with UTSA only -111 yds in a 7 pt loss while LT was -200 yds in a 31 pt loss.

**KENTUCKY by 14 over Missouri** - This game was moved to this date after MO had their game cancelled last week. KY is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in this series, winning the last 2 as outright upsets. The 'Cats were almost a td underdog last week but smoked Tenn 34-7. KY only finished with a +7 yd edge but got 3 straight TO's in the 1H including B2B pick-6's. KY has scored 28 points with the defense in the last 2 games. The Tigers pulled an upset of their own, beating LSU as 2 td dogs prior to the unscheduled bye week. KY is rushing for 206 (4.8) but most of that came against Ole Miss's lowly D and they haven't topped 200 rush in their other 3 games. MO is holding foes to 106 (3.5) rush ypg. The Tigers have allowed 66% completions which could give KY QB Wilson a spark. Wilson is hitting 61% but he's been held under 150 pass ypg in each of their L/2. KY is 13-4 ATS off a SU win and we think the 'Cats get their 3rd straight win by 2 td's.

**4★ CINCINNATI over Cleveland** - Following their 1st loss since the ssn opener LW in Heinz Field against the Steelers where their offense was held to just 7 pts, 12 FD's and 220 yds, the Browns head South to take on a Bengals squad that blew a 21-0 lead in the 2Q LW at IND (Colts 4 pt win, 430-398 yd edge). In their Thur Night matchup earlier this ssn, the Bengals (+6) went 75/16pl for a TD with :43 left for the backdoor cover (35-30 defeat). In fact, CIN has now covered 10 of the L/12 in this series dating back to the midway point of 2014. After going 11 years without being a DIV AF, the Browns found themselves in that role on 2 occasions LY with very porous results (0-2 SU/ATS, 9 pt avg loss). With CIN covering 4 of their L/5 as a DIV HD, an outright upset could be possible. **FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 7**

**3★ TENNESSEE over Pittsburgh** - This matchup was originally scheduled for Wk 4 before being PPD due to Covid. The Steelers were able to remain undefeated a week ago against an up-and-coming Browns squad as their defense held CLE to just 7 pts, 12 FD's and 220 yds. The Titans meanwhile also remained perfect disposing of the Texans in OT (RB Henry 212 rush yds & 2 TD's). In their last matchup back in '17, the Steelers put up 40 pts in a 23 pt victory (Roethlisberger 299 yds & 4 TD). With the Titans having covered 5 of their L/7 as a NDIV HD including a big win against BUF a few wks back, we'll side with them here after their offense put up a franchise-best 601 yards a week ago. **FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 7**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ LA CHARGERS over Jacksonville** - The Chargers return to action following a rescheduled bye week having failed to cover 15 of their L/21 matchups overall including a 3 pt OT loss inside of the Superdome 2 wks ago. The Jaguars meanwhile have now dropped 5 consecutive matchups since their surprising Wk 1 victory over the Colts. In their home meeting with the Lions a week ago, DET had a solid 403-275 yd edge. These 2 met a year ago with the Chargers (-3) going into JAX and finishing with a 525-252 yd edge in a 45-10 blowout victory. With victories in 7 of the L/8 overall (8-0 ATS) against the Jags, we're leaning in the direction of the home squad in this one. **FORECAST: LA CHARGERS by 16**

## OTHER PLAYS

**Ny Giants at PHILADELPHIA - Thursday** - After earning their 1st win of the ssn LW at home against WAS where they had 24-16 FD and 337-240 yd disadvantages (WAS went for 2 and the win after TD w/:43 left), the Giants head to DIV rival PHI having covered 13 of their L/16 when listed as an AD. Despite just a 1-4-1 record coming into this matchup following a loss at home against the Ravens (failed 2 pt conv w/2:00 left that would have tied gm), the Eagles may still be the favorite to grab the NFC East title following the injury of QB Prescott in DAL. The Eagles have come out victorious in each of the past 6 meetings (4-2 ATS) against the Giants with a 9 pt avg MOV during that span. They have however gone just 4-12 ATS when listed as a HF including an 0-2 spread mark so far in 2020. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**Dallas by 7 over WASHINGTON** - Following a MNF home matchup against the Cardinals where bkp QB Dalton earned his 1st start for the injured Prescott, the Cowboys head North to take on a Redskins squad that they've won 7 of the L/8 against (6-2 ATS) including a 2-game sweep of WAS a season ago (31 & 10 pt victories). WAS is back at home for the 3rd time in 4 weeks after a road trip to the rival Giants that saw them fall just short of a comeback win (went for 2 w/:43 left trailing by 1), while DAL has yet to cover a game in 2020 as of presstime, they are an outstanding 15-4 ATS in NFC East matchups. With WAS going just 4-10 ATS prior to a bye and being held to just 108 tll yds in their most recent home matchup against the Rams (Wk 5), we have no issue leaning in the visitor's direction here.

**ATLANTA by 7 over Detroit** - Following their 1st win of the 2020 campaign LW in MIN which also happened to come under interim HC Morris (QB Ryan 371 yds & 4 TD's), the Falcons return home to take on a Lions squad that picked up a solid win in JAX after their bye week (DET 25-16 FD & 403-275 yd edges). The Lions have dropped 5 in a row ATS in this series (1-4 SU) including a 30-26 home defeat against the Falcons in '17 (ATL 428-324 yd edge). With just a 3-10-1 ATS run overall for DET coming in and the pressure now off of the Falcons, we'll go ahead and call for the home team to claim a 2nd consecutive victory.

**NEW ORLEANS by 3 over Carolina** - The Saints return from their bye week riding a 2-game winning streak that includes a comeback OT win over the Chargers on MNF back in Wk 5. The Panthers meanwhile saw their 3-game winning streak snapped LW at home against CHI (3.5★ LP Winner on Under 45.5). The Saints have won 6 of the L/7 in this series (3-4 ATS) including a 2-game sweep of the Panthers a year ago (34-31 win, -9). Despite that impressive run and their 8-2-1 ATS run after a bye, we're leaning with the Panthers and QB Bridgewater who is 8-3 as a starter the L2Y (5-0 LY as the Saints QB).

**Buffalo by 13 over NY JETS** - Following a MNF night matchup against the Chiefs that was orig scheduled for Thur (Covid), the Bills head on the road looking for the series sweep over the Jets. In their 1st meeting back in Wk 1, BUF (-6) jumped out to a 21-3 HT lead in the eventual 10 pt victory (31-15 FD & 404-254 yd edges). The Jets have been abysmal so far in 2020 as LW's 24-0 defeat in MIA (held under 300 yds for 5th time TY) was their 6th consec SU & ATS loss to begin the year. The Bills have been a DIV AF on just 7 occasions dating back to 2008 going just 2-5 ATS in that span. Despite that mark and the Jets' 11-4 ATS run as a DIV HD, we find it difficult to lean with a home team that's well on their way to the #1 pick in next year's NFL Draft.

**Green Bay by 1 over HOUSTON** - While the Texans got into the win column in the debut of interim HC Crennel 2 wks ago against the Jags, LW's trip to Nashville proved to be a tougher task as the Titans remained undefeated after a 42-36 OT victory (TEN 601-412 yd edgel!). The Packers meanwhile are on the road for the 2nd consec week after watching their 10-0 lead quickly evaporate with the Bucs scoring 38 unanswered points in a 28 pt victory (GB just 13 FD's & 201 yds). GB owns a 3-1 all-time edge in this series (2-1-1 ATS) including a 21-13 (-6) home victory back in '16. Despite the series success and an 8-2 ATS mark against AFC foes coming in, the Texans are a perfect 5-0 ATS prior to a bye and should be able to keep this matchup close.

**Seattle by 1 over ARIZONA** - Following a 5-0 start to the ssn that included a come-from-behind victory over the Vikings prior to their bye week (GW TD pass w/:15 left), the Seahawks head in the desert with extra rest to take on a Cardinals squad that's on short rest after a MNF trip to DAL. In their most recent matchup back in Wk 16 a year ago, the Cardinals (+9) went into SEA and picked up a surprising 27-13 upset win holding the Seahawks to a season-low 224 yds. While SEA has covered 5 of the L/7 after a week off, keep in mind that the Cardinals are 5-1-1 ATS in this series (3 outright upsets) dating back to the midway point of '16.

**NEW ENGLAND by 7 over San Francisco** - The 49ers and Patriots are among the NFL's most storied franchises with 11 SB titles between them. Following an 8 pt win LW at home against the Rams where they finished with a 390-311 yd edge, the 49ers head into Foxboro having covered 10 of their L/14 against AFC foes. NE meanwhile had no success on the offensive end LW at home against the Broncos as they were held to just 12 pts, 14 FD's and 288 yds in the 6 pt defeat (latest NE has been under .500 in a ssn since 2002). The Patriots have won 4 of the L/5 in this series SU & ATS including a 30-17 road victory back in '16. While SF QB Garoppolo would love to get a victory over his original team (NE bkp QB from '14-'17), the Patriots' 7-3 ATS mark against the NFC and 10-4 ATS run as a NDIV HF has us backing them here (roster potentially near 100% following earlier Covid outbreak).

**Kansas City by 11 over DENVER** - The Broncos picked up one of 2020's most surprising victories LW in Foxboro behind a suffocating defense that allowed just 12 pts and 288 yds. The Chiefs meanwhile head into "Mile High" on short rest after their Thur night trip to BUF was switched to MNF due to Covid issues. The Chiefs have picked up the season sweep in each of the past 4 years (7-1 ATS) with a 12 pt avg MOV during that span. With a 19-7 ATS overall mark inside of the AFC West for KC along with DEN's obvious struggles in the same role (7-18-1 ATS vs DIV foes), we're leaning in the direction of the visitor here as the Chiefs have actually covered 7 of their L/10 road trips dating back to the start of LY.

**Tampa Bay at LAS VEGAS - SNF** - Rematch of SB XXXVII, a game that saw the Bucs (+4) and HC Gruden knock off his former (and now current) Raiders squad by a 48-21 score. Since that SB defeat the Raiders have won 3 of the 4 meetings in this series SU & ATS including a 30-24 road win at Tampa as 2' pt chalk in 2016. While the Bucs & Packers was expected to be a shootout, it was the TB defense that stole the show as they allowed just 201 yds in the 38-10 victory. The Raiders meanwhile return to action following a Wk 6 bye sitting at 3-2 on the year including a surprising road win as a DD dog in Arrowhead 2 wks ago.
