KEY SELECTIONS

4★ UAB over Old Dominion - 1st mtg. The Blazers got 167 yds from WR Watkins and RB Stanley filled in for inj'd RB Brown with 92 yds LW in UAB's 33-14 (-12) win at UTSA. UAB finished with +272 yd & +14 FD edges. ODU switched to JUCO transfer QB deWeaver (orig Mich St) but got the same results LW, putting up just 206 yds in a 14 pt loss at Marshall (+15). The Monarchs were outgained 444-206 and outFD'd 27-11. UAB has held 4 of their 6 foes under 300 yds. ODU has topped 300 yds just once and their opp's recorded their ssn low yards allowed the last 2 weeks. ODU avg 121 ypg less than their foes allow (#121 in FBS). UAB avg 44 ypg more than their foes allow (#48 in FBS). The Monarchs don't have a WR topping 100 yds, nor do they have a RB topping 200 yds and their defense showed signs of tiring LW (all'd ssn high 236 rush). HC Clark is 12-2-1 ATS at home and UAB is 23-9-1 ATS since their rebirth. ODU is playing B2B on the road and UAB has a bye on deck.

FORECAST: UAB by 24

3★ Tulsa (+) over CINCINNATI - The host in this series is 3-0 SU/0-3 ATS. The last meeting was in '16. Cincy has a bye on deck. The 'Cats followed their emotional win over UCF with a misleading 38-23 (-7) win at Houston LW. Cincy was out'd 424-394 & benefitted from 2 td 'drives' of 35 yds or less as well as a 2 yd IR td. TU enters having lost 3 of 4 SU following their 45-17 (pk) loss vs Navy, cashing our 3★ on these pages LW! The Hurricane gained 46% of their ttl yds in the 4Q when the gm was already decided. TU does have an improved D, but Cincy's is still much better, holding foes to 108 ypg below their avg (#19 FBS)! TU is 16-8 as an AD. This will be a totally looking offense the improved Golden Hurricane will have to defend and we expect a 1 possession game.

FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 8

3★ EASTERN MICHIGAN (+) over Western Michigan - Broncos have won 5 straight over Eagles SU but are 0-2-1 ATS the L/3. LTH WM (-3) needed OT to pull out a 20-17 win. LY EM (+4) was off back-to-back OT losses but led 17-14 3Q but WM took 27-17 lead w/9:24 left. EM scored td w/20 (27-24) but WM recovered outside. Both faced CM TY. WM won 31-15 as a 16' pt HF being outgained 437-432 & out FD'd 31-22 but went 24-4 into 4Q (CM 264 yds in 4Q). EM trailed CM 28-3 in 3Q & lost 42-16 as a 5' pt AF being outgained 587-285 but were only out FD's 24-22 as 258 of CM's yds came on just 4 td plays (3 of 64+ yds). EM opened TY 2-1 SU & ATS incl a 34-31 upset of Illinois but needed a miracle blk punt td to get past an FCS foe & are now 0-2 in MAC play. LW EM led Ball ST 17-7 at HT & 23-14 late 3Q but allowed L/15 with 3 TO's in Ball ST territory their L/4 poss to lose 29-23 as a 1' pt HF. LW WM trailed Miami 6-0 mid-2Q when a WM 74 yd IR td turned the game around as they led 21-6 despite being outgained 238-178 at HT. WM only led 21-16 early 4Q before scoring L/17. With 2 misleading finals, look for EM to keep it closer than expected.

2★ Southern Miss over LOUISIANA TECH - The winner of this game stays in contention in CUSA West standings. SM is 4-0 SU/3-0-1 ATS in this series. LY LT led 20-14 then SM went 85/16 pl & scored go ahead td w/6:02 left. LW LT destroyed UMass 69-21 (-31). SM led NT 28-20 at half then held NT to 114 yds in the 2H and won 45-27 (-3). QB Abraham has topped 350 in all 3 of his gms vs Group-of-5 foes. LT is +66 ypg against our #129 sked. SM is +58 ypg against our #59 sked. The Golden Eagles avg 72 ypg more than their opp's allow (#29 in FBS) and QB Abraham is hitting 69% (9-4 ratio). LT allows 37 ypg more than their opp's avg (#91 in FBS) and are #83 in pass eff D. SM has solid edges in all 3 phases. SM is 7-3 ATS on the road vs Group-of-5 foes. LT is 0-4 as a HD.

FORECAST: Southern Miss by 7

2★ Florida St over WAKE FOREST - FSU is 7-0 SU/4-2-1 ATS. First time since '09 that FSU is the dog. The 'Noles were in a bad stop against an angry Clemson team LW and got crushed. They were outgained 367-43 at half and trailed 42-0 (+27) before adding 2 late bgb time td's. WF outgained Lville 668-520, were +18 FD's yet never led and lost 62-59 (-7). WF is +126 ypg and their OFF avg 105 ypg more than their foes allow on avg (#8 in FBS). FSU is -65 ypg against our #14 sked. WF is +126 ypg but they've only faced our #78 sked. FSU has a ST's edge and WF allowed KR's of over 80 yds and a 50 yd PR LW. The 'Noles had covered 3 straight prior to LW and we think they bounce back with a strong performance. WF is just 3-8 ATS at home.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 16TH

South Alabama at TROY - Battle for the Belt. LY Troy (-12.5) went to SALA & avenged their '17 upset loss by winning 38-17. Troy & SALA both enter here off 11 days of rest. In Troy's last gm (42-10 loss at Mizou) QB Barker left the gm 1H w/ a knee inj & is a ? here (CS). SALA last played GS & lost 20-17 in 2OT despite gaining just 4 FD's & 247 yds. Before the Mizou gm Troy's OFF was avg'g 513 yds & 41 pts and SALA's DEF is all'g 465 ypg the L/4 wks. SALA's OFF is avg'g just 275 yds & 13 pts vs FBS foes this ssn. SALA is just 4-9 ATS in SBC road gms the L/4Y, while Troy is 5-7-1 ATS in SBC home gms over that same span. The home tm has lost L/4 mtgs SU & is just 1-5-1 ATS.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 17TH

Louisiana at ARKANSAS ST - Teams have split the L/8 mtgs but home tm has won the L/5 gms SU/ATS. LY LA scored a TD with 78 sec left to win 47-43 (547-478). Ark ST is off a bye, while LA is off a 17-7 home loss vs App. where their OFF was held to 254 yds & 7 pts (came in avg'g 540 yds & 44 pts). Ark ST's DEF has been hit w/ inj's this ssn & are all'g 604 ypg & 45 pts the L/4 wks. LA avg's 282 rush ypg and can get on track here as Ark ST's run D is all'g 245 ypg the L/4 wks. Ark ST can score the ball (306 pass ypg, 34 pts) despite losing QB Bonner, but faces a LA DEF all'g just 314 ypg the L/5 wks. Ark ST HC Anderson is 4-1 ATS as an SBC dog, but LA HC Napier is 4-0-1 ATS on the road in SBC play incl 2-0 as an AF.

Ucla at STANFORD - Both schools enter fresh off a bye. Stanford has dominated this series of late, winning 11 in a row SU (10-1 ATS)! LY Cardinal QB Costello threw for 344 yards & 5 td's in the 49-42 (-6) win, but has missed the L/2 games (CS) and Davis Mills has completed 71% w/a 4-0 ratio in relief. On the subject of inj's, UCLA QB Thompson-Robinson missed the Bruins last game (CS) and Austin Burton was unable to lead a victory over downtrodden Oregon St at home. Stanford had their best game of the ssn in their last outing, gaining a ssn high 482 yds & holding Washington to a ssn low 294 yds, while the Bruins are all'g 503 ypg & are #127 in our pass eff D rankings. Stanford is on a 36-24-1 ATS run & is 8-4 ATS at home, while UCLA is 6-10 ATS away from the Rose Bowl.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 18TH

FAU by 10 over Marshall - Marshall is 5-1 SU in this series and has covered 3 of the L/4. The visitor is 4-1 ATS. Last week we went with FAU as our 5★ and the Owls came through with a 28-13 (-11) home win over Middle Tennessee. RB Davidson had 149 yds and MT was shutout in the 2H. MU enters off a 31-17 (-15) home win over ODU. The Herd held a 444-206 yd edge. MU is +53 ypg and their defense allows 24 ypg more than their opp's avg (#88 in FBS). FAU is -15 ypg but are +103 ypg in their L/4. QB Robinson is completing 64% (13-2) while QB Green is only comp'g 57% (8-5). MU had 8 sks LW incl 4.5 from DE Darius Hodge while FAU has all'd at least 4 sks in 3 of their 5 FBS games. HC Kiffin is 12-6-1 ATS vs CUSA foes. MU is on a 5-13 ATS run incl 1-5 TY.

Pittsburgh by 3 over SYRACUSE - Pitt owns this series, winning 12 of the L/14 and they are on an 8-2 ATS run. We used Under 56 for our Thursday Night Marquee a week ago and picked up an easy winner (College Marquees 5-1 LW, just \$12, call 1-800-654-3448) with Cuse getting held to 10 pts and 341 yds in a 6 pt loss (+4). The Orange Oline once again struggled, giving up 8 sks for the 2nd time this ssn. Pitt is fresh off a bye after winning 3 str games incl 2 outright upsets. The Panthers have at least 3 sks in every game and are #2 in FBS with 27 on the ssn. Cuse avg 38 ppg at home and only 26 ppg away from the Carrier Dome the L/3Y. Pitt is #4 in the FBS in pass attempts this year and QB Pickett is comp'g 61% (6-4). The Orange only allow 51% completions and are #34 in our pass eff D rankings. Pitt is 9-14 as chalk Cuse plays much better at home so we only have Pitt winning by a lg.

Ohio St by 27 over NORTHWESTERN - Both schools enter fresh off a bye. OSt has dominated this series, winning 28 of the L/29 SU including 7 in a row (6-1 ATS). The last meeting was LY's B10 Championship game, which the Buckeyes won 45-24 (-14) & the last regular season matchup was OSt's 24-20 (-26) nailbiter in '16. NW hasn't hosted this series s/13. 'Cats starting QB Johnson DNP (CS) in their 13-10 (-7) loss at Nebraska. Aidan Smith has played in each of the L/3 games & NW has been held under 300 yds in 4 of their 5 games. The Buckeyes' look like one of the most complete teams in the nation, led by QB Fields, who is completing 70% w/a 18-1 ratio & RB Dobbins, who is avg 181 (7.7) rush ypg vs FBS foes. OSt is #1FBS on

offense, avg 206 ypg more than their opponents allow & has held 5 of their 6 to ssn lows in ttl yds! NW is on a 18-11-1 ATS run & is 4-2-1 as a HD.

FRESNO ST by 18 over UNLV - Fresno leads series 15-6 SU. LY FSU won 48-3 at UNLV (466-302). Fresno is 7-1 SU in MW home gms under HC Tedford, with the loss coming vs UNLV in '17. UNLV is off a 34-10 upset win at Vandy (QB Rogers missed gm), but their OFF is avg'g just 336 yds & 19 pts vs FBS foes. UNLV's run OFF avg'd just 73 ypg the L/2 wks, but vs Vandy put yd 206 rush yds. FSU's DEF is solid, as they hold foes to 19 ypg under their ssn avg, while UNLV's DEF is all'g foes to gain 86 ypg above their ssn avg. Tedford is 12-5-2 ATS in MW play & is on a 5-2 ATS run as DD MW chalk while UNLV HC Sanchez is on a 1-5 ATS slide as an AD in MW play.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 19TH

VIRGINIA by 1 over Duke - This game brings fond memories as our first two Sept 5★'s were on Virginia over Duke way back in 1984 & 1985. UVA is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series. Duke was 7 pt chalk LY but UVA won 28-14. The 'Hoos were +7 TO's in those 4 mtgs. Duke picked up a 41-23 (-17) win over G Tech. The Jackets finished with a ssn high 379 yds but 281 yds came after Duke jumped out to a 38-7 2Q lead. UVA enters off a 17-9 (+2) loss at Miami. The 'Hoos actually held a +53 yd edge but settled for 4 fg's (1 missed) and fumbled on the UM20. QB Harris has only completed 46% (1-2) the L/2W. UVA is #48 in pass eff D but lost CB Hall (likely 1st round pick) to a severe leg injury. The 'Hoos have yet to face a true duel threat QB like Harris (380 rush, 4.6) and HC Cutcliffe is 26-13 as an underdog. UVA has 4 str non-covers so we expect revenge minded Duke to keep it closer than expected.

MIAMI, FL by 21 over Georgia Tech - Miami is 8-2 SU/7-3 ATS in this series. Two 'former' Temple HC's meet here. HC Diaz was hired to replace HC Collins last year but Diaz left Temple after the 'Canes job opened up. The Jackets put up a ssn high 379 yds LW but 281 of those came after GT fell behind 38-7 2Q at Duke. Miami bounced back from a losing effort to beat Virginia 17-9 (-2) last Fri night. The 'Canes never trailed but were held to a ssn low 265 yds and outgained by 53 yds. GT is -111 ypg while Miami is +65 ypg vs FBS foes. UM is holding opp's 95 ypg below their avg (#24 in FBS). The Canes are #26 in our pass eff D rankings and Jackets' QB Graham is only completing 45%. Surprisingly Miami has put up the most yards that 3 of their opp's have allowed all ssn. GT is playing their 2nd of B2B road gms and UM hasn't traveled since wk 2. The Jackets have yet to cover under HC Collins (0-6 ATS) so we have the Hurricanes by 3 td's.

Clemson by 25 over LOUISVILLE - Clemson has won all 5 mtgs (covered L/3) incl LY when the Tigers handed the Cardinals their largest margin of defeat in 3 decades, 77-16 (-39). LW CU was angry off the bye after losing their #1 ranking following their close defeat of NC. The Tigers slaughtered FSU with a 367-43 yd edge at half and led 42-0 before FSU added 2 bgb time td's. UL has topped 500 yds in B2B games. LW the Cards knuckled off undefeated WF 62-59 (+7). UL never trailed despite getting outgained 668-520 and outFD'd 40-22. CU allows just 105 (3-0) rush and faces the ACC's #2 rusher in Javian Hawkins (622, 5.6). UL QB Cunningham is a ? (inj LW) but bkp QB Conley has been solid (65%, 4-1). The Cards D has allowed their L/3 foes to put up their ssn high in yards (583 ypg) and all 3 went over 300 pass yds incl 423 LW vs Wake Forest. This will be QB Lawrence's breakout game and Clemson is on a 12-2-1 ATS run vs ACC foes.

Army by 3 over GEORGIA ST - 1st mtg. Army is off a 17-8 loss at WKU (held to 208 yds) while GST exploded for 350 rush yds at CC. GS'ts DC spent 12 ssn's at Wofford (3 yrs as DC, Woff is an option tm) and knows how to defend the option. GS'ts LB cch & RB cch also have exp coaching an option tm. GS't is all'g 200 rush ypg (5.6 ypc) and are all'g foes to gain 46 ypg above their ssn avg. GS't's OFF is avg'g 254 rush ypg, while Army has all'd 275 rush ypg the L/2 gms. Army is 30-7 SU vs non-power 5 tms the L/4Y & are just 2-9 ATS as an AF dating back to '10, but GS't is 2-4-1 ATS as a HD the L/3Y. Given GS't's cch's knowledge about the option, we think this will be a close gm.

Buffalo by 20 over AKRON - The Zips are 11-7 all-time vs the Bulls but just 3-7 s/07. LY Akron only trailed 10-6 at HT. Zips got into UB terr 3 times in 2H, but came away empty & UB won 24-6. Buffalo is off a bye after a heartbreaking loss OT to Ohio as they missed the would be game tying xp but covered as a 3.5 pt HD. Akron was off the bye last week, when they lost 26-3 as a 14' pt HD to rival Kent St and it could have been much worse as Kent St settled for 4 FG's. UA's QB Nelson threw for 202 yds but was less than 100% missing some throws & was sacked 3 times. UB has the advantage on offense (#109-#130) & on of defense (#75-#128). Buffalo has been relying on the run game avg 230 ypg & 4.62 ypc. That is not good news for Akron that is allowing 200 ypg & 4.62 ypc. UB is 2-4 SU & ATS covering 2 of their L/3. UA is 0-6 SU & ATS losing by an avg 22 ypg & failing to cover by an avg 13 ppg. We look for the Bulls to run over the Zips.

MARYLAND by 3 over Indiana - Indy is on a 3-1 SU/ATS series run, but there has been 3 outright upsets in the 5 B10 meetings & the home team is 3-0 SU/ATS. LY The Terps finished with 542-374 yd & 27-18 FD edges, but was -3 TO's and lost 34-32 (+1). This is MD's lone home game in a 4 week stretch. The Terps enter off a 40-14 (-3) loss at Purdue, where they were out'd 547-403 & outFD'd 24-15. With st'g QB Jackson unavailable (CS) Tyrrell Pigrome completed just 54% & finished w/a 0-2 ratio. It took Indy just :10 to score a td (fastest in Memorial Stadium history) as they blew out Rutgers 35-0 (-27) last week. WR Philyor is the 1st Hoosier w/ B2B 100 yd rec games & Indy finished w/557-75 yds & 25-6 FD edges! MD is 5-2 off a SU loss & we'll call for their run game to have better results than last week.

Houston by 14 over UCONN - It's homecoming in Storrs & the host has won the only two prior meetings including the Huskies pulling the outright upset over the #15 ranked Cougars here in '15. The last matchup took place in '16. UH is travelling outside of Texas for only the 2nd time in the L/7 wks. The Cougars enter 0-2 SU in conf action for the 1st time s/02 following their 38-23 (+7) loss vs Cincy, QB Tune, already taking over for D'Erig King (RS), was limited in practice & hit just 9-27-184-2-3 as 3 QB's were used. UH did finish w/a 424-394 yd edge & trailed by just 5 late 4Q (-4 TO's). UConn avoided getting shutout w/2:27 left in their 49-7 (+34) loss at Tulane LW. The Huskies were out'd 634-234 & outFD'd 32-14. UH is 3-9 as road chalk so we'll call for the Cougars to win by 2 td's.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 9 over Coastal Carolina - 6th mtg (GS leads 4-1), but just 2nd time GS is the home tm. LY Coastal (+7) trailed just 13-10 at HT but GS scored 4 TDs in the 2H to win 41-17 as GS ran for 401 yds. GS is off a bye, which they needed after being beat up the F/5 gms. Two wks ago QB Werts came back & ran for 102 yds, and RB Kennedy made an impact in his return & GS is putting up 263 rush ypg the L/2 gms. CC's OFF is improved this ssn (424 ypg, 34 ppg) but this team relies on its stout DEF, as they are all'g just 324 ypg, but have all'd 451 ypg the L/2 gms. GS HC Lunsford is 7-2-1 ATS in home gms here, while CC is 1-8-1 ATS in SBC play the L/2Y. CC's D can keep this one close, but we like GS to win by over a TD.

Central Michigan by 17 over BOWLING GREEN - BG 23-18 vs CM incl 7-2 s/96, but HT is just 1-4 s/04. LY was a tie of two H's. Both came in with MAC losing straks (CM 6, BG 8). CM led 13-0 at HT as a 9 pt HF. BG took a 17-13 lead into 4Q & won 24-13. LW BG shocked rival Toledo 20-7 as a 26' pt HD!!!!, ending a 9 gm losing streak to UT. That was their first sign of life since their opener (FCS foe) as they had lost 4 straight SU & ATS (all 4 by 28+) incl a 42 pt loss to MAC foe Kent St. CM after losing their MAC opener to rival WM has won & covered putting up 42 pts in their last 2. CM has the edge on both offense (#94-#118) & defense (#84-#125). CM is 5-1 ATS incl 4 str covers & we'll ride the streak as we expect the Falcons to come down off their emotional win.

UCF by 26 over East Carolina - It's homecoming in Orlando. UCF is on a 5-1 SU/ATS series run, but the host is 1-4 SU/ATS and there has been 2 outright upsets the L/5 meetings. LY the Knights were out'd 496-427 & outFD'd 29-22, but forced 5 TO's and won 37-10 (-21). Both schools enter fresh off a bye. UCF has gained the most yds all'd by 4 of their 6 opponents, while EC is #108 FBS on D, all'g 30 ypg more than their opponents avg. The Knights have played much better at home, avg 54 ppg & 615 ypg, while the Pirates are all'g 32 ppg & getting out'd by 155 ypg on the road. That being said EC is starting to adjust to the new schemes and after losing to Temple by just 10 in their last outing, we expect them to keep this one closer than anticipated.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 1 over Nc St - The visitor had won 4 straight until LY when BC, playing w/o RB Dillon, lost 28-23 (+6). BC has covered 5 of the L/6 incl the L/3 mtgs. BC is fresh off a bye. With 4 of their L/6 on the road they desperately need to win this game for bowl hopes. AJ Dillon has topped 100 in 4 straight. He faces a tough test against the Wolfpack D that allows just 67 (2.3) rush ypg. NCST knocked off Syracuse LW 16-10 (-4). The Wolfpack recorded 8 sks for the 2nd straight week. BC has allowed just 2 sks all year and 0 in their L/3. The Eagles may be w/o QB Brown but bkp Grosel is a dual threat and nearly led a comeback win 2 wks ago at Lville. BC is 11-0-1 as dogs incl 5 outright upsets and we can't help but ride with the Eagles who won us 3 straight LPS plays prior to their bye.

IOWA by 12 over Purdue - It's homecoming in Iowa City. The Hawkeyes had won 4 in a row SU in the series, but has dropped B2B meetings. While Iowa has covered 4 of the L/6, the visitor is 6-2 SU/9-0 ATS & there has been 2 outright upsets the L/7 matchups. LY the Hawkeyes entered ranked #19, but lost 38-36 (+3), their most pts in a loss s/11! Iowa has lost B2B games SU following their emotional & physical 17-12 (+3) setback vs Penn St. The Hawkeyes finished w/a 356-294 yd edge, but were -2 TO's, leading to 10 Nitanny Lion pts. The Boilermakers snapped their 3 gm losing skid LW, beating MD 40-14 (+3), finishing with 547-403 yd & 24-15 FD edges. PU revamped their OL & bkp QB Plummer threw for a car high 420 yds with Brycen Hopkins the 1st TE in schl history w/DD catches in a gm s/011! PU is 19-7 as an AD. No opposing B10 team has won more games at Kinnick Stadium than PU and while we aren't calling for the upset, we do think the Boilermakers keep it closer than expected.

OHIO by 10 over Kent St - Ohio has won 5 straight & leads series 44-25-1. LY KS (+12) hit a 75 yd td pass on the 1st pla & led 14-0 Q1 & 20-7 at HT. Ohio never led until a td with 1:28 left (2 pt ng) to take a 27-26 lead. They sealed the win with an incl 58 sec later. KS finished with a 472-414 yd edge. LTH KS (+18) led 3-0 but then allowed 48 unanswered (incl 28 in 3Q) being outgained 474-166. Ohio has surprising struggled TY as they are 2-4 SU & 1-5 ATS & their only FBS win was a 21-20 OT win thanks to Buffalo missing their XP in OT. LW the Bobcats as a 6 pt HF led NIU 21-10 with a 13-6 FD & 222-138 yd edge at HT but trailed 29-21 early 4Q. They tied the gm at 29 & 36 but allowed a final play GW 37 yd fg. Kent St despite facing the tougher schedule (#58-#96) is 3-3 SU & ATS with 2 of those losses coming vs then-#8 ranked tms (Aub & Wisc). They are in unfamiliar territory as they are in sole possession of 1st place in MAC East at 2-0 beating BG 62-20 as a 11 pt HF & rival Akron 26-3 as a 14 pt AF LW, despite setting for 4 FG's. This is KS third straight road game & we look for Ohio, with no room for error to play up to their potential.

TEXAS by 16 over Kansas - KU is on a 5-2 ATS run in the series, but the host has covered 9 of the L/13 meetings. This is the lone home game for TX in a 6 week span, but the Jayhawks enter fresh off a bye, while the 'Horns covered again in their physical & emotional 34-27 (+10') RRR loss vs Oklahoma, cashing a LPS 3★! TX finished w/a 25-21 FD edge and while they all'd 511 yds, that was actually 132 yds below what the Sooners avg! KU has been held under 300 tll yps twice and HC Miles fired his OC during the bye. RB Williams avg nearly 7 ypc LY, but is being held under 5 ypc this season. The Jayhawks are all'g 260 (5.3) rush ypg in B12 play. TX is 4-10 as home chalk. Based on the situation we'll call for TX to win by just over 2 tds.

Wisconsin by 32 over ILLINOIS - It's homecoming in Champaign. UW is on a 5-2 ATS run in the series, but the host is 7-3 ATS. LY the Badgers ran for 357 (6.6) yds and held IL to 13 FD's in the 49-20 (-24) blowout. While the Badgers are travelling for the 1st time in 7 weeks, they are in a Michigan S/Ohio St sandwich. Either the Badgers are really good, or they caught Michigan St in a Ohio St hangover as they held Sparty to 149 yds & earned their nation leading 4th shutout of the ssn, winning 38-0 (-10'). RB Taylor was held under 100 yds for the 1st time, but UW still finished w/402-149 yd & 22-7 FD edges! The Badgers have held 4 of their 6 foes to ssn lows in tll yds & is #1 FBS on D, holding opponents to 217 ypg below their avg! With IL st'g QB Peters (inj. CS) out, rFR Matt Robinson made his 1st car start in LW's 42-25 (+23') loss vs Michigan. The Illini trailed 28-0 late 1H, but showed no quit and pulled to within 3 mid 4Q, before all'g 2 tds including a 1 yd scoring 'drive'. Still, IL was out'd 489-256, their 3rd straight game being held under 300 tll yds! IL is 7-12 as a HD & is on a 12-22 ATS run, while UW is 10-4 ATS on the B10 road & is 10-2 as road chalk.

UTAH ST by 20 over Nevada - New leads series 18-6 SU, but USU has won L/2 mtgs here. 5 of the L/7 mtgs have been decided by 4 pts or less. Nev is 4-2 this ssn, but HC Norvell was livid after his 5-3 loss to UH (-3 TO's) & they responded w/ an 41-38 win vs SJSt as well as QB Henry looked solid (352 pass yds). USU is off a bye and are still avg'g 533 yds & 39 pts vs tms not named LSU. Nev gave up 512 yds to UH's prolific OFF 2 wks ago and LW gave up 405 pass yds and now face NFL QB prospect Jordan Love with their #112 rated pass D. Aggies are 13-8-1 ATS as DD MW chalk & are 11-3-1 ATS at home the L/4 while Nev is on a 4-9 ATS slide in road gms.

Boise St by 14 over BYU - Boise leads series 7-2 SU (just 3-6 ATS). LY BYU was sk'd at the 2 yd line to end the gm (Boise won 21-16). LTH Boise (-8) held BYU to 238 yds & won 24-7. BYU is off a loss, but in the L/4 gms are all'g 423 ypg & allow opposing QB's to hit 67%. Boise's OFF is steady under true frosh QB Bachmeier (1547, 62%, 9-3) avg'g 488 yds & 37 pts, but Bachmeier left gm LW & may miss this gm (CS). Boise's DEF has 19 sks, only allow QB's to hit 53% & holds tms to 125 rush ypg while BYU lost QB Wilson 2 wks ago (hand inj.) & RS frosh Hall takes over an OFF avg'g 387 yds and 22 pts. Home tm is 3-6 ATS in series. Boise HC Harsin is 19-8 as an AF while BYU is 1-5-1 ATS under HC Sitake as a HD.

WYOMING by 17 over New Mexico - WY leads series 37-34 & have won 2 straight SU/ATS, outscoring NM 73-6 & holding them to just 267 tll yds. WY is off an 26-22 loss to SDSU while NM dropped their 9th straight gm to CSU 35-21. NM has the #130 pass D (395 ypg!) but hold foes to 128 ypg (3.7 ypc) while WY rush attack is avg'g 233 yds & only avg's 115 pass ypg (QB Chambers hitting just 38%). NM does run the ball well (220 ypg, 5.0 ypc) but WY DEF holds tms to 90 rush yds & have topped their sack tll from LY (20). NM is just 1-5

ATS the L3Y as a MW AD and are on a 2-10 ATS slide, while WY is on a 12-6 ATS run in MW gms the L3Y & are 5-1 ATS as MW chalk the L3Y.

UTAH by 9 over Arizona St - AZSt owns this series, going 13-2 SU dating back to 1977. From '13-'16 Utah was 4-0 ATS vs AZSt but have lost the L/2 gms SU/ATS. Utah is holding tms to 140 ypg under their season avg at home (#9 FBS) and AZSt's OFF is avg'g 37 yds under what their foes allow (#103 FBS). Utah is all'g just 272 ypg on DEF incl just 53 rush ypg (#2 FBS) and AZSt has yet to get their run gm going (134 ypg, 3.4 ypc). Utah's OFF is avg'g a decade-best 466 ypg (228 rush ypg, just 4 sks all'd) while AZSt's run D allows just 92 ypg (3.0 ypc). Utah is 8-2 ATS the L4Y as a P12 HF while AZSt is 12-6-1 ATS as a 'dog the L3Y. AZSt should keep this gm within single digits.

Toledo by 7 over BALL ST - After 2 straight losses to Ball St, Toledo has won 5 straight in the series by an avg 23 ppg(3-2 ATS) incl 2 straight covers as a 19+ pt Fav. LY Ball St was without their starting QB (OFY) & trailed 21-0 into 2Q & 31-7 into 4Q losing 45-13 (+19), but were only outgained 531-437. LTH the Rockets won 58-17 as a 25 pt AF. This is the Cardinals first HG in over a month. They are surprisingly in sole possession of 1st place in the MAC West, because they have been able to take advantage of their MAC foes mistakes for 2 come from behind wins with 10 pts off 3 NIU TO's & 7 pts off 4 EM TO's (3 on final 4 poss). After opening with a loss to KY, UT had won 4 straight (3-1 ATS) incl their MAC opener over WM 31-24 (-1'). After winning 9 straight over rival BG, they were a 26 pt AF but trailed 10-0 & 17-7 at HT before losing starting QB in 3Q & lost 20-7. With QB Guadagni status unknown their is no opening line, but even without him we look for a talented & very focused UT tm to not make the mistakes Ball St needs to keep this close.

MIAMI, OH by 1 over Northern Illinois - Played for the Mallory Cup. NIU is 5-2 SU vs MU s/1998 but just 2-5 ATS. LY NIU had already clinched the MAC West & still finished with a 369-201 yd edge but after allowing a Miami fg drive to only lead 7-6 threw a pick-6 11 sec later & lost 13-7 as a 7 pt HF LTH ('15) NIU led 21-0 after 1q & cruised to a 45-12 win as a 15 pt AF. Miami has played the tougher schedule (#22-#53) TY. LW the Huskies trailed at Ohio 21-10 at HT as a 6 pt AD but took a 29-21 lead & won 39-36 on a last sec 37 yd FG. LW the RedHawks led WM 6-0 before giving up a 74 yd IR td. After trailing 21-6 at HT they got within 21-16 early 4Q before falling 38-16 as a 13 pt AD. NIU is making 2nd straight trip to Ohio & their 3rd road trip in 4 wks while Miami & had a bye 2 wks ago. We will take the fresher team & the points.

CALIFORNIA by 12 over Oregon St - It's homecoming in Berkeley & Cal enters fresh off a bye. The Bears are on a 4-1 SU/ATS series run & is 3-1 SU/ATS when hosting. LY Cal entered on a 3 game losing skid, but finished with a 539-241 yard edge in the 49-7 (-7) blowout. Bear st'g QB Garbers DNP (inj) in the closer than expected 17-7 (+20) loss at Oregon & is expected to remain out this week. Bkp QB Modster is a UCLA transfer with 3 career starts, but will be facing an Oregon St defense that is #120 in our pass eff D rankings after going up against Oregon's #2 ranked unit in his most recent start. OSt has a bye on deck following their 52-7 (+14) blowout loss vs Utah (6th straight Early Bird winner available for FREE on Button 9 comp line every Monday!), their worst home loss s/91! QB Luton had his streak of 181 passes w/o an int snapped, the Beavers avoided the shutout w/56 left & were out'd 503-217. OSt is on an 8-17-1 ATS run & we'll call for Cal to win by DD's.

Oregon by 6 over WASHINGTON - Since 2004, UO is 13-2 SU/ATS against the UW with all but 2 of those being by DD. LY UW missed a GW FG with no time left 4Q & then UO (+3) won it in OT 30-27. UW went on the road LW & won at Ariz 51-27 (450-360) while UO dismantled Colo 45-3. The Ducks OFF gets a ton of attention (461 ypg, 36 ppg) but their DEF has held 5 straight foes to under 300 yds & are holding foes to 128 ypg under their ssn avg (#12 FBS). Both tms faced Stanford on the road this ssn & UO held them to 234 yds & 6 pts while UW lost 23-13, all'g 482 yds. UO also beat Cal at home this ssn & UW lost at home to Cal 20-19. UO is on an 8-4 ATS run as P12 chalk while UW is just 1-3 ATS as a HD under HC Petersen.

USC by 7 over Arizona - It's homecoming in Los Angeles & this is the lone home game in a 5 week stretch for USC. The Trojans are on a 6-0 SU/4-2 ATS series run, but the visitor is 3-1 ATS & the dog is 10-4. LY USC appeared in control leading 24-0 mid 3Q, but all'd 20 unanswered and held on to win 24-20 (-3). The Trojans enter having lost 3 of 4 after LW's emotional & physical 30-27 (+10') setback at Notre Dame. USC trailed 20-3 mid 3Q, but fought back and cut the lead to 3 late 4Q. True frosh QB Slovis returned from a concussion that forced him to miss most of the L/2 gms & completed 69% of his throws. AZ had their 4 gm winning streak snapped in LW's misleading 51-27 (+6) & won vs Washington. The 'Cats led 17-13 at HT, but were -3 TO's. The Huskies benefitted from a fmlr ret td & 2 td 'drives' that started in AZ territory. USC is 3-9 as home chalk. LW's result for AZ gives us some value here as we think the 'Cats only lose by a td.

WASHINGTON ST by 8 over Colorado - As P-12 foes Wash St is 4-2 SU/ATS again CU. LY Wash St (-6.5) scored 31 straight pts & won 31-7. CU is off a 45-3 loss at Ore, while Wash St gave up the GW TD w 34 sec left vs Ariz St. Their only common P-12 is Ariz St & CU took down a ranked Sun Devils tm on the road 34-31. Wash St is all'g 572 ypg & 48 ppg in conf play, but are avg'g 510 yds & 37 pts in P-12 play. CU has the #114 pass D (all'g 307 pass ypg) & faces a Wash St pass OFF avg'g 453 ypg & QB Gordon hits 71% with a 25-6 ratio.

Florida by 5 over SOUTH CAROLINA - UF has won 3 of the L/4 but SC covered the L/2. The Gators were in Death Valley at night LW and led 28-21 (+13') before LSU scored the L/21 pts. UF was on the LSU2 late but failed to score and secure a backdoor cover. SC is off a massive upset, beating UGA 20-17 in OT (+21'). The Gamecocks lost QB Hillinski late 3Q and were outgained 468-297 but won, largely thanks to CB Mukamuam, who had 3 int's incl a pick 6. Florida had 26 sks in their F/6 gms but was held sackless LW. The Gators avg 72 ypg more than their opp's allow on avg (#21 in FBS). SC avg 12 ypg more than their foes allow on avg (#74 in FBS) and could be down to their 3rd string QB and their LT Hutcherson also left with an inj. HC Muschamp is a great underdog coach (12-4, 9 outright upsts in 3Y) and UF is off B2B huge efforts vs Aub & LSU.

Baylor over OKLAHOMA ST - It's homecoming in Stillwater. BU has won 4 of the L/5 SU & is on a 3-1 ATS run in the series, but the host is 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS. OKSt enters fresh off a bye & this is their lone home game in a 4 week stretch, but the Bears have a bye on deck. The Pokes have gained the most yds all'd by 3 of their 5 FBS opponents & feature the nations leading rusher in Chuba Hubbard, who is already over 1,000 yds & avg 182 ypg, but they've also all'd 2 of their 3 B12 opponents to finish with more ttl yds than they avg. BU was ranked for the 1st time under HC Rhule LW & has won 8 in a row SU dating back to LY after the Bears emotional 33-30 (-11) 2OT win over Tx Tech. BU sent the game into OT on the final pl of regulation after an 89/11pl drive culminated in a 19 yd fg. OKSt is 5-13-2 as B12 chalk, losing outright 9 times, while BU HC Rhule is 12-1 SU as a dog of less than 7 pts! Charlie Brewer hadn't thrown an int until LW & the Pokes have all'd a 14-3 ratio so we expect a huge bounce back performance. We'll call for the outright upset! **FORECAST: Baylor by 3**

GEORGIA by 30 over Kentucky - UGA is 9-0 in this series and have covered 6 str by 10.5 ppg. The Dawgs enter off a shocking loss at S Car, 20-17 (2OT) as over 3 td chalk. QB Fromm hadn't thrown an int all year then threw 4 vs the Gamecocks and normally reliable K Blankenship missed 2 fg's. HC Stoops was forced to play WR Lynn Bowden at QB due to Sawyer Smith's inj. Bowden threw for 78 and rushed for 196, rallying KY from a 13-0 2Q deficit to win by 4 (-7). UGA is +224 ypg while KY is +4 ypg. The Dawgs hold foes 139 ypg below their avg (#4 in FBS). KY has allowed 173 (5.1) rush ypg and UGA avg 238 (6.2). This will be an angry Dawgs team ready to bite a KY team play'g with a WR at QB and a leaky run D. UGA is still on a 17-7 ATS run vs SEC foes.

Tcu by 6 over KANSAS ST - KSt is on a 1-3 SU/3-1 ATS run in the series, but the host is 1-3 SU/ATS. LY 'Cats QB Thompson was injured in the 1Q and they also missed a PAT, mishandled a fg snap & muffed a punt in the 14-13 (+9) loss. Both schools enter fresh off much needed bye's as KSt has dropped B2B games while TCU has lost 2 of their L/3. The 'Cats are avg 218 (4.9) rush ypg, but are #114 FBS on offense, avg 70 ypg less than their foes allow, while TCU has held 2 of their L/3 opponents to ssn lows in ttl yds & is #5 FBS on D, holding foes to 151 ypg below their avg. The Frogs are avg 242 (5.3) rush ypg and KSt is all'g 244 (6.2) rush ypg over their L/3 gms. With TCU having the more established staff we don't have an issue backing the Horned Frogs in a game that will be labeled as 'must win.'

Lsu by 24 over MISSISSIPPI ST - LSU has covered just 1 of the L/5 vs MSU but did hold the Bulldogs to 3 pts and 260 yds in their first go round vs HC Morehead LY. LSU beat UF 42-28 (-13) in Death Valley at night LW, though they did trail 28-21 3Q and UF got to the LSU late before getting SD. MSU was 6' chalk LW but were held to a ssn low 267 yds at Tenn and lost 20-10. QB Stevens was benched in the 3Q. The Vols had 8 sks in their F/5 gms but MSU allowed them to get 7 and RB Hill had just 13 yds. In their toughest test to date, MSU allowed 56 pts and 578 yds 3 wks ago at Aub. LSU has yet to be held under 42 pts and avg 171 ypg more than their opp's allow (#2 in FBS). RB Hill is in for another tough game against LSU's defense that allows just 92 (2.8) rush ypg. We will ride the red-hot Tigers who are on an 8-0 ATS run.

ALABAMA by 36 over Tennessee - Bama is 12-0 SU and covered the L/3 incl LY when the Tide's 58 pts was the most scored by either team in series history. Tenn entered LW with just 8 sks all year, then posted 7 vs Miss ST. The Vols were 6' dogs and pulled the upset 20-10. We picked up a 3* LP Totals Winner on Over 61 LW as Bama rolled A&M 47-28 (-17). The Tide did only finish with +59 yd & +1 FD edges. If QB Mauer is able to play (Concussion LW, CS), this would be the third true frosh QB that Bama has faced in SEC play this year and surprisingly Bama failed to cover the F/2. Tenn is #52 in pass eff D and lost S Flowers for the ssn LW. QB Tagovailoa has a 27-1 rating. The Tide avg 169 ypg more than foes allow on avg (#3 in FBS). Tenn avg 21 ypg less than their foes allow on avg (#96 in FBS). Tenn has lost the L/3 by 39, 38 and 37 pts so we call for Bama to win by 36 of course. Based on their rate of improvement (1 pt per year) the Vols will finally beat Bama in 2056.

OKLAHOMA by 28 over West Virginia - It's homecoming in Norman & this is OU's lone home game in a 5 week stretch. WV is travelling for the 1st time in 4 weeks & has a bye on deck. The Sooners are on a 7-0 SU/4-0-1 ATS series run. LY a trip to the B12 Championship game was on the line. There was 1,372 ttl yds and OU advanced with a 59-56 (-3) win. We cashed a 3* LPS winner going against the Sooners in their emotional & physical 34-27 (-10) RRR win. OU did finish w/a 511-310 yd edge, but was outFD'd 25-21. QB Hurts continued on his Heisman quest with 4 ttl td's & 131 rush yds. WV has dropped B2B games following their 38-14 (-10) loss vs Iowa St. St'g QB Kendall was inj'd on the 1st series (CS) & the Mountaineers were held to 190 yds. Bkp QB Allison did complete 75%, but for only 5.8 yds/attempt. WV is 4-2 as an AD and we'll call for OU by 4 td's.

Auburn by 16 over ARKANSAS - Auburn has won 3 straight by 38.6 ppg but LY Ark actually held a 290-225 yd edge despite losing 31-3. The home tm is 7-3 ATS. Ark has lost 3 straight by a combined 15 pts after LW's 24-20 (+7) loss at KY. The Razorbacks allowed 330 rush yds against the 'Cats who were playing a WR at QB due to inj's. Ark did lead 13-0 but QB's Starker finished with just 41 pass yds and was replaced by Ben Hicks. Aub enters fresh off a bye after their loss in the Swamp 2 wks ago. Ark is +111 ypg against ur #73 sked. Aub is +90 ypg against ur #4 sked. The Tigers allow just 101 (3.3) rush ypg and they face the SEC's leading rusher Rakeem Boyd (617, 5.8). Ark is 3-1 as a HD and Aub does have LSU on deck. **Texas A&M by 10 over OLE MISS** - Texas A&M 2-5 ATS but won & covered the L/2 vs UM. The QB's Plumlee and Corral split reps LW at MO. Plumlee rushed for 143 yds and threw for 103. UM only trailed 9-7 at half but couldn't contain the Missouri offense and allowed 351 yds & 26 pts in the 2H but got a td with 5:51 left, securing a backdoor cover. A&M lost at Bama LW 47-28 (+17). The Aggies are holding foes 106 ypg below their avg (#21 in FBS) and they just held Bama to a ssn low 448 yds. Ole Miss avg 82 ypg more than opponents allow (#24 in FBS) and run for 230 (5.0). A&M's 3 losses are to Clem, Aub & Bama and they were only -22 ypg in those. UM's losses were Memphis, Cal, Bama & MO and were -80 ypg in those. HC Fisher is 10-3 as chalk at A&M.

MEMPHIS by 6 over Tulane - UM is playing with revenge after their 11 game series win streak was snapped in LY's 40-24 (-14) loss. The Tigers were held to ssn lows in ttl yds & FD's. TU is on a 3-1 ATS series run, but the host has covered 3 straight. This is UM's lone home game in a 4 week span. The Tigers enter off their 1st loss of the ssn, an emotional 30-28 (-4) setback at Temple. TO's handed UM a 16-0 defeat, but they rebounded and only trailed by 2 early 4Q. The Tigers finished w/a 491-456 yd edge and had a controversial reversal end their comeback. TU enters off a 49-7 (-34) blowout over UConn. The Green Wave had a shutout until all'g a td w/2:27 left & finished w/634-234 yd & 32-14 FD edges. UM is 16-5 ATS & is 10-2 as home chalk, while TU is 2-6 as an AD. We'll call for the revenge seeking Tigers to win by just under a td.

North Carolina by 9 over VIRGINIA TECH - VT has won the L/3 mtgs and covered 5 of the L/6 but NC actually pulled out the cover LY. The Tar Heels were +6' and about to go up DD's when they fumbled and VT drove 98 yds for the GW td. NC enters fresh off a bye. VT had an underwhelming 17 pt win against a poor FCS foe after their upset win over Miami 2 wks ago. VT is -1 ypg against ur #119 sked. NC is +53 ypg against ur #5 sked. The Tar Heels avg 77 ypg more than their foes allow (#26 in FBS) and QB Howell is hitting 63% w/a 15-3 ratio. VT allows 46 ypg more than their foes avg (#106 in FBS) and are only #72 in our pass eff D rankings. Blacksburg isn't what it used to be, with VT losing 5 of their last 6 home games vs P5 foes. We are calling for NC to win by nearly DD's.

Minnesota by 21 over RUTGERS - It's homecoming in New Brunswick & this is MN's 1st ever trip here. Despite being B10 rivals s/14, this is just the 2nd all-time meeting ('16). The Gophers have won just 17 of their L/63 B10 road games SU, but did beat Purdue in their last road trip, while the Knights have failed to win a B10 game 3 of the L/4! RU enters on a 5 gm losing streak following their 35-0 (+27) loss LW at Indy, their 3rd time being shutout TY. The Knights have been outscored 165-7 in B10 play and were held under 50 pass yds for the 9th time s/16! MN is ranked for the 1st time s/14 following their 34-7 (-7) win over Nebraska, cashing our 3* LPS play on the UNDER (LPS Totals now 17-10, 63% TY)! The Gophers finished w/a 450-299 yd edge & are 6-0 for the 1st time s/03 & they've run 8 straight dating back to LY for the 1st time s/1948-49! RU is 6-3 ATS hosting B10 foes. While we don't feel RU pulls the upset, we'll call for them to keep this closer than expected as MN is play'g with unbeaten pressure.

Iowa St by 7 over TEXAS TECH - It's homecoming in Lubbock. ISU is on a 3-0 SU/ATS series run, winning by 28 ppg & covering by 29 ppg! The host is 3-1 SU/ATS & there has been 5 outright upsets in the L/9 meetings. LY TT led by 3 at the half, but gave up the lead for good w/4:39 left in the 40-31 (+6) loss. The 'Clones are on the 2nd of B2B away games following their 38-14 (-10) win at WV. ISU knocked WV QB Kendall out of the game on the 1st

NAVY by 9 over USF - The host is 2-0 SU/ATS, winning by 10 ppg & covering by 3 ppg. The last meeting was in '16 so this is USF HC Strong's 1st time seeing the Navy triple option. The Bulls did defend the option twice LY vs GT & Tulane, all'g 392 (7.2) rush ypg! The Middies followed up their emotional win over AF with a 45-17 (pk) route over Tulsa, cashing a 3* on these pages as well as a marquee on Saturday (college marquee) on a 5-0 ATS run! Navy led 28-3 at HT & finished w/a 423-323 yd edge. USF enters off an emotional 27-23 (+4) come-from-behind win over BYU. The Bulls took their 1st & only lead of the game with 7:37 left and were outgd' 439-315 & outFD'd 26-17. Navy is 7-1 ATS & is 12-6 as home chalk, while USF is 6-10 ATS, but 24-10 as an AD.

APPALACHIAN ST by 17 over Ulm - App is 3-1 SU but just 1-3 ATS as SBC foes. In last mtg ('17) App St (-8') lost at ULM 52-45 in a gm that featured nearly 1,100 yds. Both tms played over a wk ago, so come in with rest. App held a potent LA OFF that was avg 540 ypg to just 254 yds & 7 pts. App comes in avg'g 219 rush yds & faces a ULM run D all'g 229 ypg. ULM's D overall is all'g foes to gain 117 ypg above their ssn avg (#128 FBS) while the App D is holding foes to 32 ypg under their ssn avg. App St is 9-4-1 ATS as DD chalk the L/2 & since '15 App St is 16-0 SU in reg ssn gms in which they had over a wk to prep for while ULM is on a 6-14 ATS slide.

Missouri by 28 over VANDERBILT - MO has won the L/3 mtgs but Vandy did keep it closer than expected LY, 33-28 (+15). The home tm is just 2-5 in SEC mtgs. HC Mason's hot seat is scorching after LW's embarrassing 24 pt loss as over 2 td chalk. The Doers were outgained 378-306 and outFD'd 21-12. QB's Neal and Wallace comb'd for 16-41 for 140 yds and an int. MO played their first gm w/o LB Garrett LW and allowed a ssn high 440 yds incl 204 on the ground vs Ole Miss. The Tigers won 38-27 (-12), allowing a td for a backdoor cover with 5:51 left. QB Bryant was healthy and threw for 329. The Tigers avg 75 ypg more than their opp's allow (#28 in FBS). Vandy avg 46 ypg less than their opp's allow (#107 in FBS). This is MO's first road game since their opener. Vandy is 0-6 ATS TY and are 1-7 as HD.

San Diego St by 12 over SAN JOSE ST - SDSU is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS vs SJSU the L/6Y, but that lone ATS loss was LY when SDSU (-27) needed a FG w/ under 5 min left to win 16-13. LW the Aztecs held a WY team avg'g 248 rush ypg to 157 yds & have the #4 rush D in the FBS (all'g just 64 ypg) while SJSU avg's just 90 rush ypg. SDSU's D also is holding foes to 134 ypg under their ssn avg (#9 FBS) while SJSU's D is all'g foes to gain 113 more ypg than their ssn avg (#125 FBS). SJSU QB Love has passed for 405 yds in B2B wks but faces a SDSU pass D ranked #30. SDSU is 13-7 ATS under HC Long as a MW AF and their OFF will do enough to get them a DD road win here.

WKU by 6 over Charlotte - The home team is 2-0 SU/ATS in CUSA mtgs. Both mtgs were blowouts. 2 tms going in opposite directions. UC has lost 3 straight while the 'Toppers are in contention for a bowl after winning 3 straight. WKU is off a 17-8 (+4) upset win over Army LW where they held a 365-208 yd edge. The 'Toppers have held their L/3 foes under 300 yds and hold opp's 141 ypg below their avg (#6 in FBS). We won a 4* LPS against Charlotte LW at FIU. The 49ers (+5) were outgained 510-330 and lost 48-23. UC is allowing 232 (5.5) rush ypg and their pass eff D is ranked #119. WKU RB Walker has topped 100 yds in 4 of his 6 gms and QB Storey has won all 3 of his starts, hitting 69% (3-1 ratio). WKU has a solid def edge but hasn't topped 21 pts vs an FBS foe yet.

NORTH TEXAS by 8 over Middle Tennessee - These two last met in '16 and MT is 2-0 SU/ATS. NT's bowl hopes look another hit LW in their 45-27 (+3) loss at SM. The Mean Green now have to win 4 of their L/6 to get bowl elig. MT is in the same boat following their 28-13 (+11) loss at FAU which we used to pick up a 5* LPS winner last week! NT RB Siggers has been a big surprise with 478 yds and 7.5 ypc. MT has allowed over 200 rush yds in every game this ssn. The Blue Raiders allow 114 ypg more than their foes avg (#126 in FBS). NT is +30 ypg vs our #81 sked. MT is -108 ypg vs our #47 sked. QB Fine was banged up late LW and is a ? (CS). NT is just 3-6 as a HF so we will call for MT to keep it closer than expected.

Rice by 5 over UTSA - UTSA has won the L/4 mtgs (2-2 ATS). They've held Rice to 10 pts comb'd in the L/2. Rice enters fresh off a bye after suffering 6 straight defeats to start the ssn. Three of their losses were by single-digits but they are -120 ypg against ur #30 sked. UTSA lost at home LW 33-14 (+12) vs UAB. The RoadRunners were outgained 492-220 and outFD'd 26-12. UTSA is -82 ypg against ur #106 sked. Rice has held foes 45 ypg below their avg (#43 in FBS) and they've allowed just 127 (3.9) rush ypg in their L/4 vs TX, Bay, LT & UAB. UTSA has been held under 100 pass yds in 3 of their 6 gms. UTSA is 2-7 ATS at home.

Temple by 3 over SMU - TU is 2-1 SU/3-0 ATS as AAC rivals, covering by an avg of 8 ppg & the visitor is 2-1 ATS. The last meeting was in '16. SMU enters fresh off a bye. The Ponies are #10 FBS on OFF, avg 115 ypg more than their foes allow and has gained the most yds all'd vs 2 of their 6 opponents. TU has already beaten 2 ranked foes and enters on a 3 gm win streak following their 30-28 (+4) victory over Memphis. The Owls led 16-0 mid 2Q and never trailed, but did benefit from +2 TO's. TU is 21-6 as a dog with 13 outright upsets & is 39-19-1 ATS. Also TU HC Carey is 26-13 ATS in true road games. The Owls have already proven they can beat Top 25 ranked opponents and this is new pressure for the Ponies.

FIU by 15 over UTEP - These 2 last met in '16. FIU is 2-1 SU/ATS in CUSA mtgs. We picked up an easy 4* LPS winner on FIU LW in their 48-23 (-5) win over Charlotte. The Panthers held a 510-330 yd edge. Both RB's Jones and Maxwell topped 100 yds. UTEP enters fresh off a bye after losing 4 straight, all by DD's. The Miners avg 140 ypg less than their foes allow on avg (Dead last in FBS). FIU avg 20 ypg more than their foes allow on avg (#69 in FBS). FIU is allowing 187 (5.1) rush ypg. While it's tough to back the Miners, they have kept their L/3 within 20 pts and are 5-3 as AD while FIU is only 5-7 as HF.

Michigan by 1 over PENN ST - UM is on a 4-1 SU/ATS run in the series, but the host is 8-2 SU/ATS. LY the Wolfe's had a 210-75 yd edge at the half and blew out PSI 42-7 (-12). UM is on the 2nd of B2B away games following their 42-25 (-23) win at IL. The Wolfe's appeared to have gotten bored after leading 28-0 because they found themselves only leading by 3 mid 4Q, but responded with 2 late td's & finished w/489-256 yd & 25-17 FD edges. PSI enters off a physical 17-12 (-3) win at Iowa. The Nitnany Lions were outgd' 356-294, but led from mid 2Q on. PSI exerted a ton of energy in last weeks win and we'll call for the Wolfe's to stay focused for all 4Q this week and pull off the outright upset.

Air Force by 4 over HAWAII - Tms have met 21 times, but just 3 as MW foes & the home tm is 0-3 ATS. LTH was in '15 & AF (-6) ran for 492 yds in a 58-7 win. UH is off a tough 59-37 (438-518, -3 TO) loss at Boise LW while AF held Fresno to 268 yds in a 43-24 win. UH did face the option 2 times LY & all'd 326 rush yds to Navy and 303 rush yds to Army. AF also faced Boise this ssn & held them to 355 yds in a 30-19 loss. UH is avg'g 352 pass ypg (OB McDonald hitting 66%, 20-9 ratio) & faces the #97 pass D here. UH is 1-4-1 ATS as a MW HD under Rolovich, and while AF is the stronger tm, they aren't great as an AF in MW play (3-11 ATS L8Y) and get just a small lean here.

4★ San Francisco over WASHINGTON - Following a narrow escape against the winless Dolphins LW in South Beach in the 1st game under interim HC Callahan, the Redskins return home for the only time in a 4-week span (trips to MIN & BUF on deck). The 49ers meanwhile are making their 3rd trip to EST already TY with wins over TB (31-17) & CIN (41-17). SF remains as 1 of the L/2 undefeated teams in the NFL following a dominating effort of the defending NFC champs in LA (held Rams to 249 ypg under their ssn avg). In their most recent matchup back in '17, the Redskins ended a 4-game losing streak to the 49ers with a narrow 26-24 victory (-10'). With the roles reversed this time around as SF is now the heavy chalk, we'll call for them to add on to an already impressive 8-2 ATS mark as a NDIV AF. **FORECAST: San Francisco By 17**

3★ Minnesota over DETROIT - Following an 18 pt victory a wk ago at home against PHI where QB Cousins threw for 333 yds & 4 TD's, MIN is back on the NFC North road for the 3rd time in the young season (already lost to GB & CHI both SU & ATS). The Lions meanwhile are back at home on short rest after a MNF trip to Lambeau to take on the Packers. In their 2 meetings a season ago, the Vikings held the Lions to a combined 6 FG's in a pair of convincing victories (DET 432 combined yds). With the Lions having covered just 1 of their past 9 as a DIV HD coming in, a TD lean in favor of the visitor seems about right. **FORECAST: Minnesota By 7**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ New Orleans over CHICAGO - The bye wk couldn't have come at a better time for the banged-up Bears as they return to action following a surprising loss to OAK in London where they trailed 17-0 at HT with 14-2 FD & 208-44 yd deficits. The Saints meanwhile are back on the road for a 2nd consec wk after an impressive defensive road win at JAX (4★ Newsletter Winner) where the Jaguars were held to just 11 FD's & 226 yds. In their most recent matchup ('17) that took place in the Superdome, the Saints jumped out to a 14-3 HT lead in the eventual 8 pt victory (387-307 yd edge). With CHI having a handful of questionable players as of presstime and the Saints going 13-5 ATS as an AD, an outright upset in the "Windy City" seems quite possible for Bridgewater (4-0 SU & ATS since taking over for Brees). **FORECAST: New Orleans By 3**

OTHER PLAYS

Kansas City at DENVER - Thursday - Following a 2nd consecutive home loss LW against the Texans where HOU had 35-20 FD & 472-309 yd edges, the Chiefs head to "Mile High" on short rest to take on a Broncos squad that's now won 2 straight matchups after a surprising 0-4 start (held the Titans to just 204 yds in the 16-0 win, Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner on Under 41!). In their trip to DEN a year ago, the Chiefs needed a TD w/1:39 left to escape with a 27-23 victory (KC has now won 7 straight vs DEN, 6-1 ATS, 9 pt avg MOV). Although KC is also an impressive 14-5 ATS overall in DIV play, we're not counting out the Broncos just yet as they've actually played fairly competitive contests all season despite their porous record. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

NY GIANTS by 7 over Arizona - While wins over the Bucs & Redskins got the "Danny Dimes" era off to a good start in NY, a pair of tougher opponents has seen the Giants held to just 424 yds the past 2 weeks in B2B SU & ATS losses against MIN & NE. The Cardinals meanwhile held on to their 2nd consecutive victory LW at home against the Falcons who missed the game-tying PAT w/1:53 remaining (QB Murray 340 yds & 3 TD). In their most recent matchup towards the end of '17, the Giants were held scoreless in the desert, 23-0. With the Cardinals failing to cover 9 of their past 11 trips to EST and the Giants back at home with extra rest, we'll go ahead and give them the TD edge in this one.

INDIANAPOLIS by 4 over Houston - Following their impressive defensive performance prior to their bye week against KC where they held the Chiefs to 21 pts under their ssn avg, the Colts take on a Texans squad that they've won & covered 3 of the past 4 against with their only loss coming LY at home in OT. The Texans also had an impressive outing LW in Arrowhead as QB Watson had 322 tll yds & 3 TD's in the 31-24 upset win. With their recent success in the series along with a 7-2 overall ATS mark coming in, we're backing IND in this one as HOU has covered just 1 of their past 6 DIV AG's.

BUFFALO by 20 over Miami - After a narrow home loss LW against the Redskins where they opted to go for 2 and the win following their TD w/:06 left, the Dolphins head North to BUF where they've clearly had their share of recent struggles as the Bills have won and covered 6 of the past 7 including a 42-17 victory (-5) a year ago (381-225 yd edge). BUF meanwhile is returning from their week off (9-4-1 ATS after a bye) with just one blemish on their record so far in '16 (6 pt loss at home to NE). With the Dolphins' overall struggles (1-7 ATS run) and the fact that the Bills have covered 8 of their L/11 as a DIV HF, there's really only one way to lean in this one.

GREEN BAY by 10 over Oakland - While the Raiders are off of B2B games against the Colts & Bears followed by their bye week, this will mark their 4th consec game played away from their home venue (trip to HOU on deck). The Packers meanwhile are ending a stretch that featured 5 HG's over a 6-week span including their MNF meeting with the Lions a week ago. In their most recent matchup inside of the "Black Hole" back in '15, the Packers (-3') claimed a 30-20 victory despite the Raiders finishing with a 372-293 yd advantage. With GB on a 10-3 ATS run as of presstime and OAK failing to cover 14 of their L/18 against the NFC, we'll go ahead and give the home squad a DD lean in this one.

Jacksonville by 6 over CINCINNATI - Following a rough home outing against the Saints (4★ Newsletter Winner on NO) where they were held to just 6 pts, 11 FD's & 226 yds, the Jaguars head North to take on a CIN squad that lost by just 6 at BAL despite 26-18 FD & 497-250 yd disadvantages (CIN 92 yd KR TD). In their most recent meeting ('17), the Jaguars ended a 4-game losing streak to the Bengals with a 23-7 victory (JAX 26-8 FD & 408-148 yd edges). While the Bengals did go an impressive 8-1 ATS as a NDIV HD heading into LY, they dropped both of their '18 contests by a 75-24 combined margin. With JAX playing much more consistent prior to LW on both sides of the ball, we expect the Bengals to still be in search of their 1st win following this matchup.

LA Rams by 6 over ATLANTA - After a trio of rough performances against the AFC in which they were outscored by a 104-66 combined clip, the Falcons fell just short of the win column LW in the desert against the Cardinals (game-tying missed PAT w/1:53 left). The Rams meanwhile have dropped 3 straight games of their own as the undefeated 49ers held the high-profile LA offense to just 7 pts, 11 FD's & 165 yds. In their most recent matchup in the '17 WC Playoffs, the Falcons (+5.5) extended their winning streak to 5 in a row against the Rams who had a pair of crucial ST TO's. With revenge on the mind of LA and ATL's plethora of dismal spread performances against NDIV foes (3-14 ATS), we'll call for the Rams to get their 1st victory over the Falcons in 13 years.

LA Chargers by 3 over TENNESSEE - The Chargers and Titans have been hard teams to figure out so far in '19 as each has won games that we expected them to lose and lost games that we expected them to win. The Chargers slipped to 2-4 on the year a week ago following their 7 pt loss against the banged-up Steelers (LAC 348-256 yd edge, 3 TO's). The Titans meanwhile were dominated on the offensive side of the ball (16-0 loss at DEN) in an easy Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner on the Under 41! In their Wk 7 meeting a season ago across the pond in London, the Chargers (-6') held on 20-19 as TEN opted to go for 2 pts and the win following their TD w/:31 left (Titans 23-14 FD & 390-344 yd edges). With both teams fairly even as far as our power ratings are considered, we'll look into recent trends for this one as not only have the Chargers gone 6-2-1 ATS as an AD, but the Titans have now failed to cover 10 of their L/12 as a NDIV HF. **SEATTLE by 7 over Baltimore** - After a 4 pt win LW in CLE where we cashed a 3★ LP & 2★ Newsletter Winners (SEA 29-21 FD & 454-406 yd edges), the Seahawks return to the Pacific NW to take on a 2nd consec AFC foe in the Ravens who got another big effort from QB Jackson (236 pass, 152 rush) in their win over CIN. In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Seahawks (-11) took advantage of a severely banged-up Ravens squad with QB Wilson throwing for 292 yds & 5 TD's in the 35-6 win. While SEA has had some issues in recent outings as a HF (4-10-2 ATS run), the Ravens have had their own struggles in meeting with NFC opponents (4-11-2 ATS). With BAL also failing to cover 6 of their past 7 prior to their bye week, SEA gets the nod in this one.

Philadelphia at DALLAS - SNF - Following an embarrassing 18 pt loss LW at MIN where they allowed 113 ypg over their ssn avg, the Eagles head to DAL for the 2nd of 3 consec AG's (at BUF on deck). The Cowboys also return to action following a surprising upset loss on the road against the Jets (DAL 3 consec losses following a 3-0 start!). In their meetings of a year ago, the Cowboys would earn a pair of victories including a 29-23 OT victory at home (NFL LP 5★ GOY Winner!) where they had massive edges in both FD's (32-16) and yds (576-256). While DAL has covered 12 of their L/14 inside of the NFC East and can go all out with a bye on deck, keep in mind that PHI has already picked up one road upset TY against a Packers squad that recently knocked off this same Cowboys team. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

New England at NY JETS - MNF - The Patriots continue to roll through the '19 season following a 17 pt victory on Thur night against the Giants where they were aided by TD's via their ST's & D.
