## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ TULSA (+) over Memphis** - It's homecoming in Tulsa. UM is on a 4-1 SU/3-1 ATS series run & the visitor is 7-1 ATS. LY TU suffered its most lopsided loss of the season, 47-21 (+16'), getting held to a season low 252 yards while allowing a season high 499 yards. The Tigers are travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks and have undefeated SMU on deck, but enter off a dominant 47-17 (-3') win vs Tulane. RB Gainwell became the 1st FBS ply'r with 200+ rec & 100+ rush yds in a gm s/97 and QB White threw 5 td's! TU enters off a 24-13 (+16') loss at Cincy. The Hurricane finished w/377-317 yd & 23-18 FD edges, but QB Smith had 5 TO's. UM is 12-5 ATS away vs foes off a SU loss, 17-5 ATS & is 7-3 as road chalk. TU is 5-11 as a home dog. We've won either going with or against Tulsa each of the last 3 weeks on these pages and despite series history & the tech edges, we'll back under the radar TU here in a trap game setting.

**FORECAST: Memphis by 2**

**3★ Texas over TCU** - It's homecoming in Fort Worth. The host in this series is 3-1 SU/ATS and there's been 2 outright upsets the L3Y. TCU was on a 4-0 SU/ATS series run, but is in revenge mode after LY's loss. The Horned Frogs led 16-10 in the 3Q, but all'd 2 short scoring drives after TO's and lost 31-16 (-3'). This is TCU's lone home game in a 5 week stretch, while TX is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks, but does have a bye on deck. The Horned Frogs finished w/366-266 yd & 22-14 FD edges last week, but lost 24-17 (-3') at Kansas St. The 'Horns entered LW off their emotional RRR loss and survived Kansas, hitting the GW 33 yd fg w/no time left to win 50-48 (-21)! QB Ehlinger threw for 399 yds & ran for another 91, but the defense has now all'd 509 ypg their L/4 and 226+ rush yds in 3 of their L/4! TCU is 16-26 ATS & is 4-13 ATS at home. TX is 5-3 ATS & is 12-6 ATS away from Austin and rec'd their wake up call last week.

**FORECAST: Texas by 5**

**3★ MICHIGAN ST (+) over Penn St** - MST is on a 5-1 SU/ATS series run. The host is 3-1 SU/ATS and Sparty has pulled off the outright upset each of the L2Y. Last year MST was without 5 starters, but still won 21-17 (+13'), scoring the GW td w/19 left. Sparty enters fresh off a much needed bye following B2B losses by a combined score of 72-10 and has a bye on deck, while PST is on the final leg of a brutal 3 game stretch. We won a 3★ LPS play going against the Nittany Lions in their 28-21 (-7') win vs Michigan. PSU was outg'd 417-283, outFD'd 26-14 & was fortunate that a Wolfe's WR dropped a sure td in the EZ with less than 2 minutes left. Under HC Dantonio defense has been MST's calling card and this year is no different as Sparty is #11 FBS, holding opponents to 112 ypg below their avg. QB Lewerke was benched in the loss at Wiscy, but is expected to remain the starter. MST is 16-10 as a home dog and we're not as impressed with Penn State as the oddsmakers are.

**FORECAST: MICHIGAN ST by 3**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Arizona St over UCLA** - It's homecoming in Los Angeles. UCLA is on a 11-5 ATS series run & is 6-2 ATS when hosting. LY the Bruins had the ball with 1:33 remaining, but was SOD and lost 31-28 (+11'). AZSt is on the 2nd of B2B away games, but does have a bye on deck, following their 21-3 (+13') loss at Utah, cashing our 3★ LPS play on the UNDER! The Sun Devils had their FBS record of 125 games of scoring 10+ pts come to an end. UCLA QB Thompson-Robinson returned from inj & had 3 tll td's as the Bruins finished w/455-198 yd & 20-11 FD edges in their 34-16 (+3') upset at Stanford. UCLA is 2-9 as a home dog. Last weeks results give us value here and we have no doubt that the Sun Devils are the vastly superior team.

**FORECAST: Arizona St by 10**

**2★ MIDDLE TENNESSEE (+) over Fiu** - The home tm is 5-1 SU/ATS in this series. MT is 7-3 SU but FIU has covered 4 of the L/5. FIU has won 3 straight after beating UTEP 32-17 (-24'). RB Jones has topped 100 yds in 3 straight and QB Morgan has a 7-1 ratio in the L/4. MT enters off a 33-30 (+7') loss at NT. MT tied the gm with :28 left but a long KR led to a 22 yd GW fg. QB O'Hara had 136 pass yds and 82 rush but was replaced in the 2H by Chase Cunningham. MT allows 222 (5.3) rush ypg and 66% comp (#103 in pass eff D) but they've faced a considerably tougher sked (#56 vs #129) and the FBS teams FIU has beaten are a combined 2-15 SU vs FBS foes (wins over Akron & UMass). The Blue Raiders are 6-1 as a CUSA HD, already own a home upset over Marshall and outgained FAU on the road so we don't mind calling for a mild upset here.

**FORECAST: MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 3**

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY OCTOBER 24TH

**Smu at HOUSTON** - These in-state rivals have played every year s/05. The host has won 4 in a row SU (8-3 ATS) & there has been 4 outright upsets the L9Y. UH is playing with revenge after entering last year ranked #17 and losing 45-31 (-14), which also snapped their streak of 8 straight games scoring 40+ pts. The Cougars haven't been a dog in this series s/10. UH was down to their #3 QB in HC Holgorsen's son Logan for LW's 24-17 (-22) close call at UConn. The Cougars were outg'd 438-284 & outFD'd 23-16. Clayton Tune is a 7' for TW (CS). SMU used their bye effectively and responded with a 45-21 (-9) win over Temple LW. QB Buechele set car highs with 457 pass yds & 6 td's and WR Roberson had a car high 250 rec yds. The Ponies led by just 10 early 4Q, but finished w/33-15 FD & 655-273 yd edges. SMU is 7-0 SU for the 1st time s/82! The Ponies are #5 FBS on OFF avg 145 ypg more than their opponents allow, while the Cougars have allowed more yards than each of their L/4 foes avg. UH is 15-5-1 as a reg ssn dog.

### FRIDAY OCTOBER 25TH

**Usc at COLORADO** - USC is 13-0 SU all-time in the series and has covered 6 of the L/9. However, the host is on a 5-2 ATS run. This is CU's lone home game in a 4 week span. LY the Buff's were ranked #19, but lost 31-20 (+7). CU enters off a 41-10 (+12') blowout loss at Wazzu. The Buff's trailed 24-3 at HT & was outg'd 497-320. QB Montez was benched, but bkp Lytle was inj'd on his 1st snap and 3rd string Stenstrom's 1st pass was int'd. USC remained in control of the P12 South following their 41-14 (-9') blowout over AZ last week. The Trojans led 27-0 & all'd just 167 yds thru 3Q. True frosh RB Christon is #5 on the depth chart, but injuries forced him to play & he responded w/88 of his 103 rush yds in the 4Q! USC could be w/o 6 starters (mostly on defense) due to mounting injuries (CS)! CU is 1-4 as a home dog, but USC is 16-26 as road chalk.

### SATURDAY OCTOBER 26TH

**Uconn by 12 over UMASS** - This is the 74th all-time meeting, but just the 3rd as FBS members. LY UMass finished w/444-265 yd & 20-11 FD edges, but never led until scoring the GW td w/3:39 left. UConn hasn't travelled here s/99. The Minutemen enter fresh off a much needed bye after a 1-6 SU/ATS start to the ssn. UMass is getting outg'd by 249 ypg and is #124 on offense, avg 112 ypg less than their foes allow and dead last at #130 on defense, all'g opponents 223 ypg more than their avg! While UConn enters on a 6 gm losing streak, they played their best game of the season in LW's 24-17 (+22) loss vs Houston. The Huskies finished w/438-284 yd & 23-16 FD edges! UMass is 3-9 as a home dog. We'll call for UConn to snap their 22 game losing streak vs FBS foes in a major way!

**PURDUE by 8 over Illinois** - The Purdue Cannon is at stake & these rivals are 44-44-6 all-time! The Boilermaker's have won 3 in a row SU in the series for the 1st time since winning 5 straight from '03-'09 and have covered 5 of the L/6. However the visitor has won 6 of the L/8 SU and has covered 4 of the L/5. LY PU scored its most lopsided win of the season, 46-7 (-10'). The Boilermakers became the 1st tm to score 20 pts vs Iowa last week in their physical 26-20 (+18) loss. QB Plummer threw for 327 & WR Bell had 13-197 as PU had a chance at the end, but failed to recover the outside kick. IL enters off the biggest upset of the CFB season after their 24-23 (+30') win vs Wiscy! It was their 1st win over a ranked B10 foe s/07! The Illini trailed 20-7 late 3Q, but never quit & hit the GW 39 yd

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fg with no time left. IL did get outg'd 420-315. PU HC Brohm is 15-8 as home chalk, while IL is 9-22 as an away dog & is 13-22 ATS.

**ARMY by 10 over San Jose St** - 2nd mtg. LY was 1st mtg and Army (-16) led just 14-3 at HT, but SJSt fumbld on 4 straight 2H drives which led to 24 Army pts & they won 52-3 (395-171). SJSt faced this option this ssn (all'd 382 rush yds at AF) & last ssn all'd 341 rush yds vs Army. SJSt is t-#1 in FBS in TO margin (+11), though their DEF is still all'g 445 ypg & 29 ppg. Army avg'g 300 ypg vs FBS foes this ssn and their pass D is ranked #100 and they face a SJSt pass OFF avg'g 311 ypg (#14 FBS). Army is 30-8 SU against non P5 teams the L4Y, but SJSt is 8-3 ATS as DD dogs the L2Y and are 9-4 ATS off a SU loss the L2Y while Army is on a 4-9 reg ssn ATS slide. Army has not been impressive the L/3 wks & SJSt has faced the option & can hang around here.

**Troy by 9 over GEORGIA ST** - Troy is 5-1 SU in this series & have won the L/2 gms ATS. LTH here (17) Troy (-9) held GST to 307 yds in a 34-10 win. LY Troy (-15) put up 557 yds in a 37-20 win. Troy played last Thurs (97-13 win vs Ala) & has extra rest while GST is off a win vs Army. Troy does well vs the run, all'g just 93 ypg while GST runs the ball 60% of the time & avg's 238 ypg. GST does have a dual-threat QB in Ellington who throws for 226 ypg (16-3 TD/INT ratio) & he can exploit Troy's #126 ranked pass D. Both tms faced Ark St this ssn & GST put up 722 yds in a 52-38 home win while Troy all'd 558 yds in a 50-43 home loss. GST is just 6-12-4 ATS dating back to '17 while Troy is 5-1 ATS as a AF in SBC play.

**CLEMSON by 25 over Boston College** - Clemson has won 8 straight in this series but BC is 3-1-2 ATS. BC pulled off yet another outright upset under Steve Addazio, crushing NCSt 45-24 (+3'). AJ Dillon topped 100 yds for the 5th straight gm, finishing w/a ssn high 223 against NCSt's run D that came in #1 in the ACC. Clemson enters off a 45-10 (-24') win at Louisville. The Tigers held a 551-263 yd edge and aside from 2 int's in the EZ from QB Lawrence they dominated the entire gm. The Tigers have a HUGE defensive edge here, holding opponents to 256 ypg and 165 ypg below their avg (#2 in FBS) and their last 6 foes have been held to their ssn low yards! BC is allowing 83 ypg more than their opponents avg (#118 in FBS). Addazio is 12-0-1 as a reg ssn dog w/6 outright upsets. We can't call for the upset here but will lean with the Eagles, although beware, HC Swinney has been letting his backups run the offense and score late (td w/1:00 left in gm LW).

**Eastern Michigan by 5 over TOLEDO** - LY's 28-26 EM's win (+1') ended Rocket's 11 gm winning streak over Eagles. EM has lost 9 straight SU (2-7 ATS) in the Glass Bowl but only lost 20-15 LTH as a 13' pt dog. Toledo has opened 0-2 in MAC play for the first time s/07. They trailed BG 17-7 2H when starting QB Guadagni was knocked out of game. LW rFr QB Carter Bradley made his first college start (14-354-137-0-1) but was banged up & true frosh QB Dequan Finn, a dual-threat QB finished the game (2-4-34-0-0, 38 rush). UT trailed Ball St 38-0 at HT losing 52-14 as a 3 pt AD, being outgained 580-309. EM also started MAC play 0-2 incl a 29-23 loss to Ball St as a 1' pt HF 2 wks ago, but they were only outgained 451-372. LW we won a 3★ Power Sweep Key Selection on EM as a 8' pt HD as they upset WM 34-27 thanks to a 2H surge (24 pts) as they finished with a 547-359 yd edge. With the status of both Guadagni & Bradley? (CS), there is no opening line, but if Guadagni doesn't play we look for EM to get their first win here s/99.

**TEXAS A&M by 12 over Mississippi St** - Miss St is 3-0 SU/ATS vs A&M. 6 of the 7 SEC meetings have been decided by double digits. A&M won at Ole Miss last week 24-17 (-6). A&M was outgained 405-337 and trailed 14-10 when they returned a fumble 62 yds for td. We won a 3★ LPS going against Miss St LW in their 36-13 (+18') home loss to LSU. The Bulldogs final td came in garbage time though they did hold LSU to a ssn low 413 yds. A&M is +72 ypg against our #26 sked. Miss St is -26 ypg against our #3 sked. Miss St is 1-5 SU/ATS in SEC road games under Moorhead. Kylin Hill has just 92 yds in the L/3 but should fare better against A&M's run D that gave up 250 rush (5.7) LW. HC Fisher is 7-2 as a HF and we will call for A&M to win by double-digits.

**TEMPLE by 3 over Ucf** - UCF is on a 4-1 ATS series run and the visitor is 3-1 ATS. LY TU led 34-28 at the half, but was held to 6 points in the 2H and lost 52-40 (+11) in a game that featured over 1,300 total yards! The Owls have a bye on deck & have won 8 in a row SU at home. LW TU was ply'g their 2nd straight ranked foe and got blown out 45-21 (+9) at SMU. The Owls were outg'd 655-273 & outFD'd 33-15, but did trail by only 10 early 4Q. UCF has alternated wins & losses their L/5 games and enter off a 41-28 (-33') win vs EC. The Knights led 35-6 at HT & finished w/a 611-483 yd edge as QB Gabriel threw for a car high 365 yds, but the Owls have our #20 pass eff D. TU is 21-7 as a dog with 13 outright upsets & is 14-4 ATS off a SU loss.

**WESTERN MICHIGAN by 28 over Bowling Green** - WM is 10-4 vs BG s/95. LY WM trailed 14-0 1Q & 21-7 at HT but tied it at 28 in 3Q & 35 in 4Q taking their first lead of gm w/5:06 left & sealed it with 2 int. After shocking rival Toledo 20-7 as a 26' pt HD (UT QB inj 2H), as we expected the Falcons came down to Earth LW, as we won our 4★ Top Late Phone play on CM (-10') over BG. It was an easy 38-20 winner despite BG having a 100 yd FR td, they trailed 21-7 HT. WM lost to a much healthier Toledo team 31-24 as a 1' pt AD. WM is off a disappointing 34-27 loss to EM as a 8' pt AF, as they led the entire 1H (14-10 HT) & led 21-20 into 4Q & 27-26 before allowing a 34 yd td pass w/:36 left. At 4-4 (2-2 MAC) WM will not look past a team that upset Toledo & will not take their foot off the gas after losing late to EM, we look for WM to put the hammer down here.

**NEBRASKA by 3 over Indiana** - NU joined the B10 in 2010, but this is just the 2nd meeting as conference rivals & Indy's 1st trip to Lincoln s/77! They last met in '16. The 'Huskiers have won 9 of their L/11 games SU off a regular season bye, while the Hoosiers have lost the 2nd of B2B away games each of the L2Y. NU QB Martinez missed their last game, but got healthy over the break & is expected to return. Indy s'g QB Pennix was inj'd LW (CS) and LY's st'r Ramsey came off the bench in the 2Q to lead the 34-28 (-6') win at MD. The Hoosiers finished w/520-383 yd & 28-21 FD edges, but needed to force TO's on MD's L/2 drives to preserve the victory. Indy is 1-3 as road chalk.

**Central Michigan by 1 over BUFFALO** - CM is 7-2 vs UB incl a 20-14 win LTH ('14). CM led 14-0, but it was 14-14 until a CM 98 yd 4Q td drive. From '12-'15 CM was 12-0 vs MAC East foes, after going just 3-6 from '16-'18, they are 2-0 TY beating Akron 45-24 as 2 pt HF (533-329 yd edge) & LW as a 4★ late Phone play beating BG 38-20 as a 10' pt AF despite allowing a 100 yd FR td. Buffalo after losing their first 2 MAC gms bounced back LW with a 21-0 win at Akron as a 17' pt AF despite only having a 254-196 yd edge (+2 TO). The Bulls have been relying on their run game TY (224 ypg, 4.6 ypc), while CM has been tough vs the run (113 ypg, 3.5 ypc) incl holding Wisc 36 yds below their ssn avg. After going 1-11 LY CM is 5-3 SU & 7-1 ATS TY incl 6 straight covers and we will ride that streak, especially getting points here.

**Iowa by 6 over NORTHWESTERN** - It's homecoming in Evanston. From '11-'15 Iowa was 4-1 SU/ATS in the series, but NW is on a 3-0 SU/ATS run, pulling the outright upset each of the L3Y! LY the 'Cats trailed 3-0 at the half, but scored the game-deciding td w/9:27 left and won 14-10 (+10') to clinch their 1st trip to the B10 Title game. NW hasn't won 4 straight s/1928-32! The 'Cats enter with an extra day of rest/prep following their 52-3 (+27') loss vs Ohio St last Friday. QB Smith got the start & finished 6-20-42-0-1 as NW was outg'd 480-199. The Hawkeyes have a bye on deck & enter off a 26-20 (-18) win vs Purdue. The Hawkeyes survived after recovering an outside kick w/:24 left, but leading WR Smith was carried off by teammates late 4Q (CS). NW is 18-12-1 ATS & the dog in NW games is 16-4-1.

**USF by 4 over EAST CAROLINA** - It's homecoming in Greenville. USF is on a 8-1 SU/6-2-1 ATS series run & the visitor is 3-0-1 ATS. LY EC held the Bulls to a season low 9 FD's, but all'd the game-deciding 80 yard to run w/10:13 left and lost 20-13 (+21). USF is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks & is on the 2nd of B2B away games following their 35-3 (+15) at Navy. In his 1st game as the starter since it was announced that Blake Barnett was OFY, QB McCloud hit just 11-23-50-0-1 as the Bulls were out'd 457-264 & out'FD'd 23-13. The Pirates trailed 35-6 at HT last week, but outscored UCF 22-6 in the 2H of their 41-28 (+33) loss on the road. QB Ahlers threw for 313 yds. EC is 4-8 as a home dog & its 14-30 ATS.

**FLORIDA ST by 13 over Syracuse** - FSU is out for revenge after losing LY 30-7, getting outgained 441-240. The 'Noles were only down 6-0 at half. FSU had won 10 straight in the series prior to LY. Cuse enters off their 4th loss in 6 games, dropped a 27-20 (+3) decision vs Pitt. QB DeVito was in'd and is a ? (CS). FSU lost another game they were winning in the 4Q LW, 22-20 (+1) at WF. The 'Noles held WF to a ssn low 424 yds and led 20-19 but they missed a go ahead 50 yd fg late. The Orange are -48 ypg and their normally explosive offense is putting up nearly 100 ypg less than they did LY. The 'Noles have 0 sks the L/2 but facing Cuse's awful Oline has given up 17 sks the L/2 games!!! This is a must win for both tms' bowl hopes. FSU has never lost to Syracuse at home (4-1 ATS) and Babers who is 3-12 SU on the road vs P5 foes.

**Liberty by 3 over Rutgers** - This is not only the 1st meeting, but also Liberty's first time playing a B10 foe. RU has won 19 of their L/27 games SU vs non-conference foes. This is the Flames 1st road game vs a P5 foe this year and they dropped both last year by an avg score of 49-12. Liberty led FCS Maine 45-17 at the half LW as QB Calvert surpassed 10,000 pass yds in his career! The Scarlet Knights avoided getting shutout LW with 5:53 left in their 42-7 (+28) home loss vs MN. RU was out'd 443-189 & held under 50 pass yds for the 3rd time this ssn! Liberty is 3-6 ATS vs FBS foes.

**Southern Miss by 10 over RICE** - SM is 4-0 SU but Rice has covered 6 of the L/9 vs the Golden Eagles. Rice was in a rare spot as away chalk LW vs UTSA and lost 31-27 (-4). The Owls were put up a ssn high 369 yds but were -3 TO's incl a 34 yd pick 6, gave up the go ahead td with 5:06 left then failed to score after reaching the UTSA24. SM led LT 27-14 2Q but QB Abraham's 4 int's were too much to overcome as the Golden Eagles lost 45-30. Rice is -102 ypg and only -17 ypg in CUSA play and nearly upset LT at home earlier TY. The Owls D holds foes 36 ypg below their avg (#49 in FBS). Rice is 4-2 as a HD and SM is 1-5 ATS when playing consec road gms. We will call for Rice to keep it closer than expected.

**UTAH by 14 over California** - 12th mtg, home team is 4-0 SU & ATS as P-12 foes. Last mtg was '16 when Cal (-2) won at home 28-23 despite being outgained 442-362 & out'FD'd 30-17. Cal is off a 2-1-17 loss vs Oreg St while Utah held Ariz St to 136 yds in a 2-1-3 win. Cal's OFF in P-12 play is avg'g just 272 ypg & 15 ppg (QB Garbers in'd vs Ariz St) while Utah is all'g just 262 ypg & 13 ppg in P-12 play. Utah OFF is led by RB Moss (607 yds, 6.5 ypc) & QB Huntley (1564, 74%, 9-1) and they are avg'g 449 yds & 33 pts this ssn. Both tms have played Oreg St & Ariz St with Cal going 0-2 SU (both losses by 7 pts or less) and Utah going 2-0 SU, holding them to a comb'd 353 yds & 10 pts. Cal is on 6-0 ATS run as a P-12 road dog going back to '17 but Utah is 9-2 ATS as a HF the L4Y.

**WYOMING by 15 over Nevada** - Just 4th mtg as MW foes & WY is 3-0 ATS in those gms. Last mtg was in '16 when WY (-6) never trailed in a 42-34 win in Reno. This is Nev's 2nd MW road gm in a row, losing to Utah St 36-10 while WY is a home for a 2nd straight week, taking care of NMex 23-10 LW. Nev's pass D is giving up 317 ypg in MW play, and though WY only avg's 106 pass yds in MW play they could hit a couple big passes here vs the #88 pass D. WY's can run well (263 ypg in MW play) but bkp Swen (337, 5.0) is out 4 wks w/ a knee inj. Nev has been good vs the run this ssn (136 ypg this ssn), but did allow Hawaii to run for 5.1 ypc & USU ran for 244 yds (5.5 ypc) LW. WY's run D is all'g 101 ypg. WY is 5-2 ATS as MW chalk the L3Y while Nev is in 5-10 ATS on the road under Norvell & we'll back a WY squad that is 5-1 ATS as a MW HF under HC Bohl.

**AIR FORCE by 3 over Utah St** - As MW foes the series is tied 3-3 SU, but AF is 3-0-1 ATS the L/4 gms. LTH in '17 there were 5 lead changes in the 2H & AF (-2) won & covered 38-35 on a TD run w/ 98 sec left. USU has all'd AF to run for an avg of 313 yds the L/4 mtgs, but this ssn the Aggies are all'g just 94 rush ypg in MW play. USU had extra time to prep for the option (off a bye) and also used the bye to heal up. USU QB Love avg'd 367 pass yds the F/3 gms but the L/3 gms is avg'g just 173 yds & 3-6 ratio. USU will face a stingy AF defense all'g 336 ypg & are holding foes to 79 ypg under their ssn avg. As for the AF offense, they are avg'g 305 rush ypg (#2 FBS). AF is just 5-14 ATS the L4Y as MW chalk and USU HC Andersen was 6-1 ATS here as a conf dog from '09-'12. The L/4 mtgs have been decided by 10 pts or less & we think this is another close gm.

**Hawai'i by 19 over NEW MEXICO** - UH is 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS vs NMex as MW foes. LTH here in '15 UH (+5) gave up the GW TD w/ 55 sec left, and lost 28-27. UH was embarrassed at home LW by AF (56-26 loss) while NMex hung around w/ WY & lost just 23-10. The Lobos have all'd 351 pass ypg (#130 FBS!) and have the #128 ranked pass D. UH's pass OFF is led by QB McDonald (2284 yds, 66%, 23-10 ratio) and have the #3 pass OFF in the FBS (359 ypg). NMex does run the ball well (212 ypg), and is led by RB Ahmari Davis (543, 5.1) & Bryson Carroll (444, 6.3). UH just gave up 353 rush yds to AF last week & 203 rush yds to Boise 2 wks ago. UH is 0-3 ATS as an AF in MW play under Rolovich, but NMex is just 1-4 ATS as a HD the L2Y.

**Wku by 1 over MARSHALL** - Marshall won the L/2 vs WKU by 3 & 7 pts but WKU has covered 5 straight. The Herd enter off a 36-31 (+5) upset win at FAU. RB Knox had 220 yds (9.6) and his 17 yd to run w/36 left was the difference. WKU is a win away from bowl eligibility after beating Charlotte 30-14 (-9). The 'Toppers defense has been a huge surprise in CUSA, holding foes to 287 ypg and 125 ypg below their avg (#125). They have held all 4 CUSA foes under 300 yds and are +68 ypg in CUSA play. MU avg 494 ypg in CUSA play, rushing for 231 (5.4) in those. HC Helton already has 3 outright upsets this ssn and MU is just 4-15 as CUSA chalk so we don't mind calling for the upset.

**STANFORD by 3 over Arizona** - It's homecoming on The Farm. Stanford is on a 10-2 SU/7-3 ATS series run & is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS when hosting. The last meeting was in '16. The Cardinal enter angry with a couple extra days of prep/rest following their 34-16 (-3) home loss vs UCLA last Thursday and has a bye on deck. Stanford hadn't lost to the Bruins in 11Y! St'g a 3rd different QB for the 1st time s/1974, the Cardinal was out'd 455-198 & out'FD'd 20-11! AZ is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks and is on the 2nd of B2B away games following their 41-14 (+9) blowout loss at USC. QB Tate threw for just 47 yds & was sacked 6 times before being replaced by true frosh Grant Gunnell. AZ is 12-24 as an away dog & is 19-34-1 ATS. Stanford is 8-5 ATS at home.

**OREGON by 11 over Washington St** - Oregon went 10-1 SU vs WSU from '04-'14 but s/'15 UO is 0-4 SU/ATS vs the Cougs. In fact, WSU is on a 9-0 ATS run dating back to '10. LY UO faced WSU on the road & came in 6-0, ranked #12 & off a close win vs Wash. This ssn UO comes in 5-1, off a close win vs Wash & ranked #11. UO QB Herbert is carving DEF's up this ssn, hitting 68% for 1,882 yds & a 21-1 ratio and faces a Cougs pass D ranked #98. WSU also boasts a stellar pass attack (441 ypg, #1 FBS) led by Anthony Gordon (2981 yds, 71%, 29-7 ratio). However, the Ducks come in with the #6 pass DEF this ssn. Ducks are 6-3 ATS the L3Y as a P-12 HF. UO is 16-2 SU at home the L3Y & we like them to win outright, but it is hard to ignore WSU's ATS record in this series.

**FRESNO ST by 10 over Colorado St** - 15th mtg, but just 4th as MW foes. Last mtg was in '16 when CSU (-16) hosted Fresno & shutout the Bulldogs out'37-0. LTH in '15 Fresno (+10) covered, only losing 34-31. The Rams are off a bye while Fresno forced 5 UNLV TO's which led to 28 pts & Fresno won 56-27. CSU's pass attack avg's 319 yds (#11 FBS). Fresno's pass D ranks #45 & against 2 other tms with solid pass D's, CSU was held to 217 pass yds in both gms. Fresno took adv of a weak UNLV run D last wk (260 yds) & face a Rams run D all'g 221 ypg. CSU is 8-4 ATS as an AD the L4Y, but Fresno is 13-5-2 ATS in MW play under Tedford incl a 5-3 ATS mark as MW home chalk. Fresno is 8-1 SU in MW home gms under Tedford & while we like the Dawgs to win by DD's, CSU's OFF has a chance to keep this game respectable.

**Missouri by 13 over KENTUCKY** - KY has won 4 str (3-1 ATS). The Tigers have played 2 road games all year, losing both, -16 pt at WY in the opener -21 pt LW at Vandy. MO put up a ssn low 293 yds, 155 yds below their avg. KY played WR Bowden at QB again LW and while their offense struggled in their 3 td loss, they did hold UGA to a ssn low 270 yds and were 0-0 at half. MO is +178 ypg but they've only faced our #87 sked. KY is -10 ypg and have faced our #16 sked. MO is allowing 114 (3.2) rush ypg and the Tigers are holding opponents 97 ypg below their avg (#19 in FBS). KY is just 5-12 as a HD and we think Missouri will have a bounce back effort. MO has gone Under the total in 5 straight while KY has gone Under the total in their L/4. Could this be our Totals GOM?

**KENT ST by 4 over Miami, Oh** - Both tied with Ohio for 1st in MAC East. Home team has won 6 straight (5-1 ATS). LY Miami (-11) led 31-0 before KS scored a td w/36 left. LTH MU led 14-3 at HT but KS won 17-14 (+9). LW Miami trailed the entire 1H vs NIU but down 17-14 3Q scored 13 straight and forced a SOD at NIU42 w/52 left to hold on to a 27-24 win as a 2' pt HD. MU QB Gabbard had a career high 273 pass but the RedHawks still were outgained 350-344 as they are avg just 273 ypg. The Flashes are avg 370 ypg & 25.0 ppg (42 ppg MAC play), their most s/'12 when they won the MAC East. LW against MAC pre-ssn fav Ohio, their were 7 lead changes & it was tied at 17, 24 & 31 but KS lost 45-38 as a 7' pt AD being outgained 571-476. We look for KS offense edge (#90-#120) to be the difference here as MU has struggled on the road (24 ppg less).

**Appalachian St by 26 over SOUTH ALABAMA** - In their only trip there back in '15 App (-18) scored the GW TD w/66 sec to go & won 34-27. LY App (-25) hosted SAla and put up 517 yds in a 52-7 win. App's run gm took a hit as RB Harrington (178, 5.4) is OFY, but top RB Evans (607, 6.4, 10 TD) leads the App rush attack that is avg'g 233 ypg & ran for 302 last wk vs ULM. SAla has a porous run D, all'g 237 rush ypg the L5 gms. Tms have played 1 common SBC foe (ULM) and App won 52-57 (572-213) while SAla lost 30-17 (377-428). App is also holding SBC foes 287 ypg & 177 yds under their ssn avg. App is on a 18-4-1 ATS run dating back to '17 & are 8-3-1 ATS vs SBC foes the L2Y while SAla is 2-4 ATS as a HD in MW play under HC Campbell.

**GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 16 over New Mexico St** - GS is 4-1 SU vs NMST, but just 1-4 ATS & 3 of the gms have been decided by 8 pts or less. The lone ATS win for GS was LY when the Eagles (-10) travelled to Las Cruces & won 48-31. GS avg's 351 rush ypg vs NMST & has only been held to under 200 rush yds 1 time in the series. GS's rush attack has heated up the L/3 gms, avg'g 277 yds while their DEF is getting better, all'g 305 ypg the L/3 wks (404 ypg all'd F/3 gms). NMST is avg'g just 356 yds & 20 pts this ssn, their pass OFF has only topped 300 yds 1 time this ssn & their OL has all'd 23 sks through 7 gms. GS is 4-1 as a HF under Lunsford while NMST is just 6-13 ATS the L2Y and we'll back the Eagles in this one.

**Duke over NORTH CAROLINA** - Duke has won 3 straight in this series. The Underdog is 6-3 with 4 upsets in the L7 mtgs. LY Duke put up a ssn high 629 yds and 42-35 (-8). NC enters off an emotional 44-42 (-3) loss in 6OT. QB Howell threw for 348 and 5 TD's, but has a 20-3 record (61%). Duke only allowed 307 yds LW but allowed TD drives of 40, 21 & 34 yds and a KR TD in their 34 pt loss (+3). Duke is -20 ypg on the road but NC is -19 ypg at home. Six of the Tar Heels games have been decided by 6 pts or less and they've already suffered 2 outright upsets. Duke is 26-14-1 as a dog incl 5-2 as an AD while NC is 1-4 as a HF and series history favors the underdog. We feel that Duke will pull off the outright upset making this an easy choice for our Underdog POW!! **FORECAST: Duke by 1**

**IOWA ST by 9 over Oklahoma St** - It's homecoming in Ames. ISt snapped a 6 game series losing streak LY & has covered 3 of the L/4. Last year the 'Clones had 16 ffl's, their most in a game s/85 in the 48-42 (+9) outright upset. This is ISt's lone home game in a 5 week stretch & they have a bye on deck. ISt is 11-0 SU the L3Y in October following their 34-24 (-7) win at Texas Tech LW. The 'Clones finished w/a 560-407 yd edge & true frosh RB Hall set his car high for the 2nd straight week after running for 183 (9.6)! Our Underdog POW picked up its 2nd outright upset of the season as we went against OKSt in their 45-27 (-4) loss vs Baylor! The Pokes were out'd 536-469 & QB Sanders had 2 costly TO's in the 4Q. ISt is 27-12 ATS & was 1-4 as home chalk LY, but has covered both instances in '19. **Fau by 20 over OLD DOMINION** - FAU has won both games under HC Kiffin in this series by 30 & 29 pts, though LY it was only 32-27 in the 4Q. The Owls put up 550 & 605 yds in those gms. The Owls (-5) led 31-30 vs Marshall LW but gave up the GW to their :36 left. We went against ODU on these pages, picking up a 4★ winner (4-0 on Key Selections LW!!!) in their 38-14 (+16). The Monarchs trailed 28-0 late 2Q and were outgained 435-150. After holding their F/5 foes to 309 ypg, they've given up 439 ypg in the L/2. FAU avg 412 ypg, and QB Robison is hitting 62% w/a 13-3 ratio. FAU already owns 2 road wins this year and the Monarchs are just 12-23-1 ATS at home so we don't mind laying DD's.

**BALL ST by 6 over Ohio** - Both lead their Div, expected for the Bobcats but a surprise for the Cardinals. Ball ST leads series 15-10 (first met 1975), but Ohio has won 5 of the L7 incl 2 straight but LTH (\*12) lost 52-27. LY Ball ST led 7-0 after 1Q, but Ohio scored 52 straight before a BSU TD w/2:53 left. TY Ball ST beat NIU 27-20 as a 4 pt AD despite being outgained 388-269, benefitting from NIU mistakes (3 2H TO's). Ohio then lost to NIU 39-36 as a 6 pt HF being outgained 510-438. Ohio led the 21-10 HT but allowed NIU to score on their L/5 poss. LW in a back & forth gm vs Kent ST (7 lead chgs, 3 ties). Ohio pulled out a 45-38 SU win as a 7 pt HF. LW Ball ST against Toledo led by a 1st time starting FR QB, led 38-0 at HT & won 52-14 as a 3 pt HF (580-309 yd edge). Ball ST has the edge on both Off (#58-#83) & Def (#92-#117) and are 5-2 ATS incl 4 str covers, while Ohio is just 1-6 ATS incl 4 str losses. That has us going with the surprising Cardinals.

**ALABAMA by 31 over Arkansas** - Bama has won 12 straight by 23.9 ppg vs the Hogs but Ark is actually 3-1-1 ATS. We aren't sure how much longer Chad Morris can last following 12 straight SEC losses incl getting crushed at home by Auburn LW 51-10 (+19). The Hogs are -109 ypg in 4 SEC games. QB Tagovailoa was injured in the 2Q of LW's 35-13 (-34) win over Tenn. The Tide were held to a ssn low 373 yds with 259 coming in the 1H when Tagovailoa was playing. Bama is likely to lean on the run game more this week without their star QB and Ark is allowing 239 (5.0) rush ypg in SEC play. The Hogs allow 32 ypg more than their opponents avg (#91 in FBS). Bama is holding opponents 84 ypg below their avg (#25 in FBS). Even without Tagovailoa, we will still call for Bama to win by over 4 TD's against Ark who is 0-6 ATS on the road under Morris.

**South Carolina by 1 over TENNESSEE** - HC Muschamp is 7-0 vs the Vols going back to his days at Florida. SC is 3-0 SU and covered 3 of the L/4. The Underdog has covered 7 straight with all 7 being decided by 6 pts or less! Tenn (+34) played much closer with Bama than expected, only down 28-13 with the ball on the GL when a fumble was ret'd 100 yds for TD. The Vols did benefit from QB Tagovailoa's inj. SC was off their massive upset of UGA LW and lost at home to Florida 38-27 (+5). SC led 20-17 in the 4Q then allowed 3 TD's in less than 5 minutes. The Gamecocks held a 387-354 yd edge. Tenn is -25 ypg against our #18 sked. SC is +10 ypg against our #10 sked. HC Pruitt has pulled 3 outright upsets incl at home vs Miss ST this year. QB Mauer suffered his 2nd concussion in 2 weeks (CS) and QB Guarantano is in Pruitt's doghouse so hard to say who the QB will be, but the underdogs track record in this series has us leaning with the Vols.

**Oklahoma by 16 over KANSAS ST** - It's homecoming in the Little Apple. OU is on a 9-2 SU/7-4 ATS run in the series and is 5-1 ATS as the visitor. LY KSt was held to a season low 13 FD's and all'd a season high 702 yards as the 37 point loss was the largest in the series s/15. The 'Cats have been home 4 straight weeks, while the Sooners are travelling for the third time in 4 weeks, but have a bye on deck. KSt is over .500 this late into the season for the 1st time s/14 following their 24-17 (+3) win vs TCU. The 'Cats were out'd 366-266, outFD'd 22-14, benefitted from a 20 yd TD 'drive', & scored the gm winning TD w/2:45 left. The Sooners responded to their emotional RRR win with a 52-14 (-32) route over WV last week. Jalen Hurts lone incomplection came via a drop. KSt is 14-4 as a home dog & is 9-4 ATS. OU has failed to cover 7 of their L/11 games.

**MINNESOTA by 10 over Maryland** - MD has won & covered each of the L2Y, winning by 18 ppg & covering by 23 ppg! LY MN was held to a season low 263 yards in the 42-13 (+2) blowout loss. The Gophers have a bye on deck, while MD is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks. MN enters 7-0 SU for the 1st time s/1960 following their 42-7 (-28) route at Rutgers, losing the shutout w/5:53 left, but still finishing w/443-189 yd & 25-16 FD edges. The Gophers have won 9 straight dating back to LY for the 1st time s/1941-42! The Terps enter off a 34-28 (+6) loss vs Indy. QB Pigrome st'd his 2nd straight gm in place of inj'd Josh Jackson (CS) & RB Leake ran for a car high 158 yds in place of inj'd McFarland (CS) as MD had a chance at the end but their L/2 possessions resulted in TO's. MN is 8-13 as home chalk. MD is 6-2 ATS off a SU loss.

**NAVY by 1 over Tulane** - It's homecoming in Annapolis. Navy is on a 5-2 SU series run, but is 4-3 ATS. The host is 7-1 SU, but the visitor has covered 4 straight. The Middies have been home 3 of the L/4 weeks, while TU is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks and is on the 2nd of B2B away games. LY Navy had their 4 game series win streak snapped. The Middies trailed 21-3 at the half, but took a 7 point lead late 4Q before all'g the GW TD & 2 pt conv w/1:27 left. Navy enters off a 35-3 (-15) blowout over USF, their 1st game not all'g a TD s/13! QB Perry became the 3rd in sch'l history with 3,000+ career rush yds. The Green Wave had their 4 gm winning streak snapped after their misleading 47-17 (+3) loss at Memphis. TU was -3 in TO's and all'd 3 TD drives to start from their side of the field. TU is 5-2 ATS.

**PITTSBURGH by 3 over Miami, FI** - Miami is 11-2 SU/9-4 ATS vs Pitt. LTH Pitt QB Pickett made his first start and Miami entered 11-0 and ranked #2. The 'Canes lost 24-14 and they've gone 9-13 SU since (8-14 ATS). Pitt is on a 4 gm winning streak after beating Syracuse 27-20 (-3). Miami was shocked as 18 pt chalk at home vs G'Tech LW, 28-21. Pitt hasn't won 5 straight since 2009. QB Pickett is completing 60% w/an 8-4 ratio and WR's Mack and F'rench are the nation's leading WR duo. This is just the 2nd time since 1977 that Pitt is favored in this series and they lost outright at home in '15 as 7 pt chalk. Miami holds opponents 76 ypg below their avg (#30 in FBS). Pitt holds opponents 90 ypg below their avg (#14 in FBS). We will call for Miami to bounce back and keep it close. With 3 of the L/4 games going under and 2 stout defenses, this could be in the mix for our Totals GOM!

**Virginia by 7 over LOUISVILLE** - UL had won 3 straight mtgs until LY when we picked up a 4★ LPS winner with UVA easily winning 27-3 (-5). This is a much different Cardinals' team under Satterfield. LW they only trailed Clemson 3-0 after 1Q thanks to 2 int's in the EZ but the Cardinals were down in the 4Q and lost 45-10 (+24). UVA only held +57 yd & +3 FD edges at home vs Duke LW but won 48-10 (-3) thanks to 5 Duke TO's and a KR TD by Joe Reed. UVA is +76 ypg against our #67 sked.

## REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK..... SAN DIEGO ST SERIES PLAY OF THE WEEK..... WASHINGTON ST TECHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK..... BALL ST

UL is +1 ypg against our #37 sked. The 'Hoos are holding opponents 108 ypg below their avg (#13 in FBS) while UL is allowing 57 ypg more than their opp's avg (#109). UVA has struggled on OFF, but UL has given up over 500 yds in 4 straight. UL is 2-8-1 ATS at home.

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 27 over Akron** - Huskies are 10-5 vs Zips incl 5 straight wins as UA's last win was in '05 (won twice incl MAC chmp gm). LY NIU never trailed, but after leading 27-10 early 3Q allowed 3 str scores before blocking the would-be tying xp & ret'd it for a 29-26 lead & sealed it with an IR TD. Both under New HC's are learning new systems. While NIU has struggled Akron looks to be starting from ground zero as they are 0-7 SU & ATS despite being a dog of 14+ four times (twice in MAC play) losing by an avg 22 ppg with the closest being 8 pts as UMAs as a 7 pt AF. They only lost 21-0 to Buffalo as a 20' HD missing 2 fg's. NIU a week after a 2H comeback win over Ohio, could not lead a 1H lead LW losing to Miami 27-24. NIU has Huge edges on both Off (#100-#120) & Def (#78-#125) & the only question is can they get out of their own way to cover such a big spread. We think Akron will help with that and attach our sled to the Huskies here.

**Texas Tech by 9 over KANSAS** - It's homecoming in Lawrence. TT is on a 10-0 SU/7-2-1 ATS series run and has covered 4 of the L/5 as the visitor. LY KU was out'd by a season high 234 yards in the 48-16 (+17) blowout, their largest loss of the year. The Red Raiders have a bye on deck & enter off a 34-24 (-7) home loss vs Iowa ST. The Red Raiders all'd 560 yds & gained nearly 20% of their total yards in their final scoring drive late 4Q. The Jayhawks were fresh off a bye last week after firing their OC and nearly pulled off a huge upset, losing at Texas 50-48 (+21). New OC Dearmon, who was a NAIA coach LY, called the plays that led to 569 yds of offense as KU drove 75/8pl and took a 1 pt lead after a 22 yd TD pass w/1:11 left. KU is 4-7 as a home dog. TT is 9-5 as road chalk. The Jayhawks remain inconsistent.

**North Texas by 4 over CHARLOTTE** - 1st meeting. UC is 4-13 SU at home vs CUSA foes but 3 of those wins did come LY. LW the 49ers were tied 14-14 2Q vs WKU but failed to score the rest of the gm and lost by 16 pts (+9). UC was held to 286 yds and outgained by 65 yds. NT was basically in a must win situation LW for bowl hopes. QB Fine returned from inj, threw for 375 yds and NT got a GW fg on the final play to win 33-30 (-7). The Mean Green avg 449 ypg and are +36 ypg against our #93 sked. UC is -13 ypg against our #100 sked. RB LeMay is #2 in CUSA with 667 (6.0). NT allows 181 (4.8) rush ypg and they've given up over 400 yds on 4 occasions. NT is just 4-10 as chalk and UC has struggled on both OFF and DEF in their L/4 so we will call for this to finish near the opening line.

**OHIO ST by 11 over Wisconsin** - Ost is on a 9-1 SU/8-2 ATS series run and the host is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS. However, there has been 4 outright upsets the L/7 meetings. The last matchup took place in the '17 B10 Title game, while the last regular season meeting was in '16. UW hasn't won in Columbus s/04. The Buckeyes enter with an extra day of rest/prep following their 52-3 (-27) win at NW last Friday and has a bye on deck. Ost was never threatened and leads the FBS with a 41.7 ppg scoring margin! The Badgers are on the 2nd of B2B away games and also has a bye on deck, but was looking ahead to this game last week and became the biggest upset victim of the ssn following their stunning 24-23 (-30) loss at Illinois! Driving with under 3 minutes to go, QB Coan was int'd at midfield and UW all'd the GW 39 yd fg w/no time left. Ost is 8-2 ATS. UW is 7-4 as an away dog. The Badgers are angry, while Ost will enter less motivated.

**ARKANSAS ST by 14 over Texas St** - Ark St is 5-1 SU vs TXSt as SBC foes, but just 3-3 ATS. LY Ark St (-11) needed a win to stay alive the SBC West race & won at TXSt 33-7 (493-375). TXSt comes into the gm off a bye, while Ark St played last Thurs & lost to LA 37-20. Both tms have faced GSt this ssn and TXSt won in 3 OT's 37-34 (350-422, +3 TO's) while Ark St lost at GSt, all'g 722 yds in a 52-38 loss (-2 TO's). TXSt Off is avg'g just 326 ypg (#115 FBS) but Ark St all's 531 ypg (#129 FBS!). TXSt does have the #52 pass DEF & it will be tested as Ark St avg's 315 pass yds & Ark ST WR Bayless leads the FBS w/ 993 rec yds & 10 TD's. Ark St HC Anderson is 13-4 ATS as home chalk vs SBC foes while TXSt is on a 2-6-1 ATS slide dating back to last ssn.

**LSU by 14 over Auburn** - Auburn has blown double digit leads each of the L2Y in this series when they were favored. Now Auburn is the dog against an LSU team that has covered every game vs an FBS foe they've played TY. We picked up a 3★ winner LW on LSU. The Tigers beat Miss St 36-14 (-18) with the Bulldogs getting their final TD in garbage time. Auburn was off their bye still angry from the loss to Florida LW and crushed Ark 51-10 (-19) with a 491-234 yd edge. QB Burrow is hitting 79% with a 29-3 ratio and faces our #17 pass eff D. LSU avg 150 ypg more than their opp's allow (#4 in FBS). Auburn is avg 77 ypg more than their opp's allow (#20 in FBS). QB Nix hit just 48% with a 2-3 ratio in his 2 SEC road starts and we can't imagine not backing the red-hot LSU Tigers. HC Orgeron is 19-6 FBS vs SEC foes and 4-0 as HF so we will take LSU by 2 TD's in Death Valley.

**Louisiana Tech by 8 over UTEP** - LT has won 6 straight in this series but UTEP has covered 3 of the L/4. The Miners were 24' pt dogs LW at FIU. UTEP kept it much closer than expected, only losing 32-17 and held a +2 FD edge while getting outgained by just 52 yds. HC Holtz pulled his underdog magic once again LW, beating S Miss 45-30 (+2). LT held a 476-437 yd edge but was outFD'd 23-19 and did get their final TD in a pick 6 with 1:27 left. LT is +62 ypg but against our #126 sked. UTEP is -84 ypg against our #100 sked. LT is 2-5 as an AF. UTEP is 3-12 as a HD but we will give a slight lean to the underdog Miners who did show some improvements LW.

**MICHIGAN by 3 over Notre Dame** - UM is on a 6-4 SU/ATS series run and the host is 8-1 SU/ATS. There has been 5 outright upsets the L/8 meetings including LY. In the season opener the Wolves trailed by 7 and were driving, but QB Patterson was strip sacked in the 24-17 (-2) loss. This is UM's lone home game in a 5 week stretch, following their emotional & physical 28-21 (+7) loss at Penn St. The Wolves finished w/417-283 yd & 26-14 FD edges and had a chance to win or send the game into OT, but WR Bell was unable to secure a TD that hit him in the chest on their final drive. ND enters fresh off a bye following 3 straight wins. These programs are very evenly matched with ND having the edge on offense & UM the edge on defense. UM is 8-4 as home chalk.

**San Diego St by 15 over UNLV** - SDSU leads the series 19-9 SU, but since '06 Aztecs are 10-3 SU/9-4 ATS in the series. LY SDSU hosted UNLV & were 24-pt chalk, but lost outright 27-24 (368-436). Teams have just 1 common MW foe so far this ssn (Wyoming) and SDSU won 26-22 & held WY to 96 yds below their ssn avg while UNLV lost 53-17 to WY as they all'd them to gain 175 yds above their ssn avg incl all'g 374 rush yds. Obad has taken over at QB due to Rogers inj (CS) and he threw for 257 vs Fresno, but also 3 int's & if he starts here SDSU has the #25 pass D. UNLV is only avg'g 101 rush yds in MW play & SDSU has the #3 rush D in the FBS (all'g 63 ypg). Overall SDSU is holding foes to 134 ypg under their ssn avg (#7 FBS). SDSU is 15-7 ATS under HC Long as an AF in MW play incl a 2-0 mark this ssn while UNLV is on a 3-8 ATS run in MW action.

**4★ INDIANAPOLIS over Denver** - Following a disastrous 24 pt home loss last Thur against the Chiefs where they were held to just 130 yds after their 1st drive of the game (Flacco sk'd 9 times, most vs DEN since Elway's rookie season of 1983), the Broncos head on their road for the only time in a 5-wk span to take on a Colts squad that's dropped the past 2 in this series by 13 ppg. IND did pick up an important DIV victory over the Texans LW in their return from bye as QB Brissett threw for 326 yds & 4 TD's in the 7 pt victory. With the Colts on an impressive 8-2 ATS run overall and DEN covering just 2 of their L/11 coming in, the home team gets the lean in this one as they look to stay atop the AFC South standings. **FORECAST: INDIANAPOLIS by 14**

**3★ CHICAGO over LA Chargers** - It's nearly panic time for LA as they head to the "Windy City" following their 3rd consecutive loss LW in Nashville to the Titans where some blown plays near the goaline in the final seconds cost them. CHI meanwhile has their own 2-gm losing streak to overcome as the Saints went into Soldier Field as a 4 pt dog a wk ago and came away with an 11 pt win. In the most recent matchup in this series back in '15, CHI (+4) overcame a 16-7 HT deficit on MNF w/a GW 25 yd TD pass w/3:19 remaining. With CHI posting an impressive 8-2 ATS mark as a HF and LA having problems on their OL at the moment due to a handful of injuries, we'll go ahead and give the Bears a confident DD lean in this one. **FORECAST: CHICAGO by 14**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Carolina (+) over SAN FRANCISCO** - After a sloppy 9-0 road win against the Redskins where they sit at 6-0 on the ssn for the 1st time since 1990 (held WAS to just 10 FD's & 154 yds), the 49ers return home to the Bay Area as one of 2 remaining undefeated teams (NE playing on MNF). The Panthers meanwhile have strung together their own winning streak with Kyle Allen as they're a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS with the backup QB under center including a 3★ Newsletter Winner over the Bucs in London prior to their bye (Wk 6). The recent series history has gone heavily in favor of CAR who have won and covered 6 in a row (s/'04) with a 12 pt avg MOV. With CAR also sporting a 10-3 ATS mark as a NDIV AD and SF having failed to cover 13 of their L/18 as a HF, we're cutting off the 49ers lean at just a point in this one. **FORECAST: SAN FRANCISCO by 1**

## OTHER PLAYS

**Washington at MINNESOTA - Thursday** - The season of misery continues for the 1-6 Redskins whose only win in '19 came by 1 point on the road against the winless Dolphins. In their 9-0 loss LW at home against the 49ers, WAS was held to just 10 FD's & 154 yds in rainy conditions. The Vikings meanwhile cashed a 3★ Newsletter Winner on the road against DET behind a 337 yd, 4 TD day from QB Cousins. In their '17 trip to D.C. where they came in as a 1 pt dog, the Vikings got a 4 TD performance from Case Keenum in the 38-30 victory. With Keenum now under center for the Redskins and former WAS QB Kirk Cousins now with the Vikings, the question will be whether or not MIN can cover this lofty spread to extend an already outstanding 22-5-1 ATS mark as a HF. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**DETROIT by 3 over NY Giants** - Following a 2-gm losing skid to some of the league's elite in the Vikings and Patriots where they were outscored by a 63-24 clip, the Giants fell yet again as 3 pt chalk LW at home against the Cardinals. DET meanwhile has dropped 2 consec matchups of their own (both inside their DIV) following a 12 pt home defeat to the Vikings where MIN had a 503-433 yd edge. In their MNF matchup in Wk 2 of '17, DET (+3) was aided by an 88 yd PR TD in the 4Q of their eventual 24-10 victory. While the Giants have failed to cover 7 of their past 10 coming in, a FG lean is all that we can offer for DET as NY has also gone an impressive 9-2 ATS as a NDIV AD.

**TENNESSEE by 6 over Tampa Bay** - Following a miracle 3 pt win LW at home against the Chargers where LAC fumbled into the EZ in the final seconds in what would have been the GW TD, the Titans are back in Nashville for a 2nd consecutive week to take on a well-rested Bucs team that is an impressive 8-4 ATS after their bye week. In their most recent meeting back in the '15 season opener, #2 overall pick Mariota easily knocked off #1 overall pick Winston by a 42-14 score. While we think this matchup will be much closer this time around, we're still going to give the Titans and bkp QB Tannehill (312 yds, 2-1 ratio LW) the edge here as they've covered 5 of their past 6 against the NFC including an outright upset of the Falcons (24-10 win, +3') less than a month ago.

**Seattle by 10 over ATLANTA** - It's been a rough season so far for ATL who dropped their 5th consec contest a wk ago at home against the Rams as ATL was held to just 14 FD's & 224 yds with QB Ryan leaving in the 2H with an ankle inj (CS). SEA on the other hand saw the Ravens deliver the upset in the Pacific NW thanks to a pair of def TD's. In their MNF meeting in SEA back in '17, the Falcons overcame a 360-279 yd deficit in the 34-31 victory. With ATL HC Quinn firmly on the hot seat following a plethora of losses to begin '19, a loss here to his former boss Pete Carroll (DC w/ SEA from '13-'14) could spell the end of his tenure with the Falcons (ATL 1-6 ATS before a bye).

**JACKSONVILLE by 3 over NY Jets** - Following a 10 pt victory at CIN a week ago where they finished with a 460-291 yd edge, the Jaguars return home to take on a Jets squad that's traveling South on short rest after their MNF meeting with the Patriots. In their trip to JAX a year ago, the Jets (+7) trailed 18-0 mid 3Q in the eventual 31-12 defeat (JAX 23-10 FD & 503-178 yd edges). While the Jets have gone just 8-20-2 ATS as a NDIV AD, we're taking the points in this one as the Jags are 0-6 SU (-1-4 ATS) with a 13 pt avg defeat the week prior to their annual trip to London.

**BUFFALO by 3 over Philadelphia** - The Eagles are back on the road for the 3rd time in as many weeks following a blowout loss in DAL where the Cowboys had a 402-283 yd edge. The Bills meanwhile returned from their bye week with a tougher than expected 10 pt win over the Dolphins (MIA 23-17 FD & 381-305 yd edges). In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Eagles (-1) connected on a 30 yd FG w/3:26 left to escape with the 23-20 home victory (BUF 412-348 yd edge). While PHI has posted a solid 14-6-1 ATS run in bouts with the AFC, we like the Bills to get their own FG victory this time around as they come in having covered 6 of their past 8 overall contests.

**LA Rams by 14 over Cincinnati** - London. Following an easy 27 pt win LW in ATL where they held the Falcons to just 14 FD's & 224 yds, the Rams head across the pond for the 2nd time in 3 years. Their '17 trip finished well in their favor as they collected a 33-0 win over ARZ as just a 3 pt favorite (28-10 FD & 425-193 yd edges). Ironically, CIN rookie HC Taylor was at that game as he spent the previous 2Y as an off asst for the Rams. In CIN's other trip to England back in '16, the Bengals and Redskins finished in a 27-27 tie. While Taylor and company are still in search of their 1st win of '19 following a 10 pt home loss to the Jaguars a week ago (JAX 460-291 yd edge), it will more than likely have to come after their bye week as CIN is just 5-10 ATS in meetings with the NFC.

**NEW ORLEANS by 13 over Arizona** - While Drew Brees is getting close to returning from inj for the Saints, bkp Bridgewater has done an excellent job as his replacement with a 5-0 SU & ATS mark that includes LW's upset of the Bears in Soldier Field (bkp RB Murray 119 yds & 2 TD's for the inj'd Kamara). The Cardinals meanwhile extended their winning streak to 3 in a row following a 27-21 win at the Giants where bkp RB Edmonds ran for 126 yds & 3 TD's. In their most recent meeting back in the '16 season, the Saints (+3) earned a 48-41 shootout victory in a game that featured 59 tll FD's & 913 yds. While the scoring won't likely be as high this time around, we're expecting the Saints to once again claim the win and cover as they're on an 8-3 ATS run prior to their bye wk.

**HOUSTON by 10 over Oakland** - The stretch of playing away from the "Black Hole" is nearly over for the Raiders who make one last road trip before getting back home for the 1st time since Wk 2 of the ssn (4 true AG's, a trip to London & a bye week since). Their trip to Lambeau didn't work out so good however as QB Rodgers threw for 429 yds (6 tll TD's) in the 42-24 victory. The Texans meanwhile are playing their only HG in a 5-week span following a 7 pt loss to the Colts. In their most recent matchup ('16 WC Rnd), a banged up Raiders squad limped into HOU and lost 27-14 thanks in part to just 203 tll yds and a -3 TO deficit. With the Raiders posting just a 2-8-1 ATS mark as a NDIV AD coming in and the Texans covering 13 of their L/19 as a NDIV, the home team gets the edge here.

**NEW ENGLAND by 13 over Cleveland** - The Patriots return home on short rest following a MNF matchup against the Jets. The Browns meanwhile are back from their bye week sitting at just 2-4 on the season after B2B non-conf defeats against SF and SEA. While CLE has been impressive as an AD with a solid 8-4 ATS mark, the Patriots have been dominant when listed as home chalk with ATS wins in 13 of their past 16. With QB's going just 5-47 SU (incl 12 consec SU defeats) when making their 1st career start against Brady & Belichick in Foxboro, this could be another long day for Mayfield (249 ypg passing w/a 5-11 ratio) and company as they continue to struggle in a year of high expectations.

**Green Bay at KANSAS CITY - SNF** - Rematch of the very first Super Bowl, a game in which the Packers claimed a relatively easy 35-10 victory. The Chiefs are back at home following a Thur night trip to DEN where they won 30-6 but lost QB Mahomes to a knee injury in the process (expected to miss here). KC has struggled in their past 2 Arrowhead matchups as IND (+11) and HOU (+4) claimed outright upset victories. The Packers remain on top of the NFC North standings following an 18 pt win over the Raiders in which QB Rodgers threw for 429 yds w/6 tll TD's. While GB has covered 7 of their L/8 against the AFC coming in, it's also worth mentioning that they now come into KC as an AF with Matt Moore expected to get the start for the Chiefs (this marks just their 2nd away matchup in a 7-week span for GB). **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

**Miami at PITTSBURGH - MNF** - Another ugly matchup on MNF for ESPN. The Dolphins remained winless LW in BUF (10 pt loss) despite 24-17 FD & 381-305 yd edges with Fitzpatrick back at QB. The Steelers meanwhile return from their bye week riding a 4-0 ATS run with the expectation that Rudolph will be back under center (missed LAC w/concussion). The most recent meeting in this series occurred in the '16 WC Rnd where PIT captured an easy 30-12 victory (2 degrees w/wind chill). While MIA has failed to cover 8 of their past 9 as a NDIV AD, also keep in mind that the Steelers have posted just a 5-15 ATS mark when listed as DD chalk.
