## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Oklahoma over TCU** - While OU enters fresh off a bye following their emotional loss in the RRR, TCU enters on a few extra days rest following their 17-14 home loss vs TT last Thurs. OU is on a 3-1 ATS series run including covering both meetings LY. This is strength vs strength as OU is #3 FBS avg 170 ypg more than their foes allow, while TCU is #7 on D holding foes to 130 ypg below their avg. TCU QB Shawn Robinson was a ? entering LW's game, but pl'y'd the entirety. OU is using a combination of Trey Sermon & Marcelias Sutton to handle the loss of pre-ssn AA RB Rodney Anderson. OU is 19-11 ATS away. TCU is 2-4 as a HD. OU will have a new DC in Ruffin McNeil & with a bye to shore up that side of the ball we feel OU will get back to their winning ways in a major statement game this week.

**FORECAST: Oklahoma by 17**

**3★ UAB (+) over North Texas** - Last year UAB trailed 30-14 at halftime before rallying to tie with :27 left. NT managed to go 32/2pl and kicked a GW fg w/ :07 left to win 46-43 (-12). The Blazers have won 4 straight, giving up just 14 pts in their L/3 games. Last week they cruised to a 42-0 (-16) win at Rice. UAB has now held their L/2 foes to a ssn low in yards. NT enters off a 30-7 (-8) win over Southern Miss where they only led 10-7 at half and their L/td came with :33 left. QB Fine threw for 292 and has completed 65% with a 16-1 ratio! UAB is 9-0 SU/8-0-1 ATS at home since they've returned to action and they've got the #26 rated pass eff D, allowing just 42% completions! The Mean Green have gone UNDER in all 7 games this year while UAB allows just 284 ypg and have gone UNDER in 5 of 6 games. Could this be our Totals GOM???

**FORECAST: UAB by 9**

**3★ MISSOURI over Memphis** - These two last met in 1999. Memphis is off an emotional loss vs UCF where they led 30-14 w/ a 339-227 yard edge at half. RB Henderson had 199 (6.4) and has gone over 174 yds in 5 of his L/6. Mizzou was w/o their top 2 WR's and trailed Bama 13-10 after 1Q but were shutdown the rest of the way and lost by 29 pts (+28). QB Lock once again struggled vs a P5 bowl foe (now 21-28 ratio) but Memphis isn't a P5 foe and they have our #85 ranked pass eff D. Missouri's top 2 WR's both missed vs Bama and are a ? here. QB White has hit 67% w/ a 15-1 ratio and Mizzou's pass D is ranked #109. Memphis has our #41 OFF avg 48 ypg more than their foes allow. Missouri is #9, avg 121 ypg more than their foes allow. Mizzou QB Lock has a 60-9 ratio vs non P5 bowl foes. Both tms have explosive offenses and leaky pass D's so could we use the OVER as our Totals GOM?

**FORECAST: MISSOURI by 15**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Auburn over OLE MISS** - Auburn jumped out to a 35-3 halftime lead last year then shut down their offense in the 2H which allowed Ole Miss to get a backdoor cover. The Tigers need a bounce-back effort after taking a surprise home loss to Tenn. The Tigers should get a struggling run game going against an Ole Miss defense that gives up 263 (5.5) rush vs SEC foes. Last week the Rebels gave up 299 (6.1) in their 30-24 (-6) loss at Ark. QB Ta'amu is hitting 65% with a 15-5 ratio. Auburn is #39 on D, holding foes to 61 ypg below their avg. Ole Miss is #101 on D, allowing 31 ypg more than their foes avg. Both teams have a bye on deck. We will take the Tigers by nearly 2 td's against Ole Miss who is 0-3 as a HD.

**FORECAST: Auburn by 13**

**2★ Buffalo (+) over Toledo** - Toledo is 4-1 SU but just 1-4 ATS since Buffalo joined the MAC but won 54-41 UT win as a 3' pt HF, when they last met in '13. UT is 23-3 SU vs MAC East tms incl 11-1 in the Glass bowl. Buffalo is having an unprecedented season as they are the first MAC team to become bowl eligible TY at 6-1 (5-2 ATS) including wins over Temple & Rutgers, with their only loss to a strong Army team. They are all alone at the top of the MAC East & is 3-0 ATS as MAC chalk. Toledo is just 3-3 with their wins over VMI, Nevada & rival BG, that just fired HC. They are just 1-1 in MAC play as after trailing 21-0 to EM, they came up a 2 pt conv short w/ :20 left in a 28-26 loss as a 1' pt AF. Buffalo had little trouble vs Akron as an 11 pt HF outscoring the Zips 14-0 in the 2H for a 24-6 win. While UT can not afford another conf loss if they hope to repeat as MAC champs, we look for the Bulls to pull out a close one here.

**FORECAST: Buffalo by 3**

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY October 18TH:

**Georgia St at ARKANSAS ST** - ASt is 4-0 all-time in this series, winning by an avg of nearly 3 td's. ASt hasn't been the tm many expected as their OFF is scoring 14 ppg less than LY & is off a 35-9 loss to SBC leader App St at home. Meanwhile GSt only has 1 FBS win & is all'g 469 ypg & 34 ppg. The Panthers run D has been especially bad, all'g 244 rush ypg. Both enter with poor ATS runs as GSt is 3-7-1 while ASt is 2-9. However ASt is 10-5 ATS as SBC home chalk s'14 & could get the pass gm going as GSt has our #115 PDR. GSt has lost their 3 road gms by 29 ppg while ASt is 20-6 SU at home s'14, winning by an avg of 25 ppg. GSt is off of a bye & ASt hasn't pl'y'd s/last Tues.

**Stanford at ARIZONA ST** - Both teams return from their bye week with the Cardinal having claimed victories in 5 of the past 6 including a 34-24 win LY in Palo Alto. Stanford did however head into their week off with some concerns following a 40-21 blowout (-4) at the hands of Utah with star RB Love sitting out with injury (CS here). The Sun Devils meanwhile have delivered at home in the desert in their past 5 matchups (both SU & ATS) including a 3-0 mark in '18. With ASU on an 11-5 ATS run as a HD over the past 11 years and the Cardinal posting a 28-9 SU mark in "true" Pac-12 road games, check back on gameday to see which way we decide to lean in this one.

### FRIDAY October 19TH:

**Colorado St at BOISE ST** - BSU is 7-0 SU in this series. LY CSU looked to have their 1st win over BSU, leading 52-38 w/under 3 min left 4Q. However BSU got 2 td passes in the L/2 min to send the gm to OT & won 59-52. CSU came into the ssn as the least exp'd in the FBS, while BSU ret'd 16 s'trs incl Sr QB Rypien. BSU came into the ssn w/high expectations, but has already dropped 2 gms, incl at home to SDSt as 2 td chalk. BSU did rebound on the road w/a narrow 31-27 win at NV. CSU is off of a close gm against NM, where they kicked the GW FG as time expired. CSU is 6-1 as an AD, but has also all'd 44.6 ppg in this series. BSU is 5-16 as a HF.

**Air Force at UNLV** - AF is 10-3 SU (7-6 ATS) in this series. Both have already faced the top MW tm in UTSt & while AF hung in there w/the Aggies (42-32 loss, gained 471 yds) UNLV got throttled 59-28 (trailing 42-7 HT). LY UNLV looked like they had this gm won, up 27-7 at HT. However, AF would flip the switch and outscored the Rebels 24-3 in the 2H & won 34-30. AF is off of a narrow road loss to SDSt, but lost QB Donald Hammond to inj 1H (CS). The OFF was still productive under Isaiah Sanders. UNLV's OFF took a significant hit with the loss of QB Rogers (#1 rusher) a couple wks ago. The Rebels D has been all'g 199 rush ypg & AF is avg 248 rush ypg. AF is just 2-7 SU in their L/9 road games.

### SATURDAY October 20TH:

**KENTUCKY by 20 over Vanderbilt** - KY has won the L/2 mtgs but Vandy was 4-1 from '11-'15. We went against Vandy last week as our 4★ Key Selection (also 3★ LPS) and picked up another winner with Florida beating the 'Dores 37-27 (-7), 4★s now 6-1 on the season!!!. Vandy was outgained by 240 yds and allowed 292 rush (4.6) and that increases to 327 (5.3) if you remove a fluky fumble by UF that was kicked backwards 35 yds. The 'Dores have allowed 257 rush ypg in their L/4 FBS games, which will be a big problem when facing KY's Benny Snell (699, 5.5). KY's D is #9, holding foes to 116 ypg below their avg. Vandy RB Ke'Shawn Vaughn (495, 6.9) was inj'd last week and he is a ? (CS). They've pl'y'd 2 common foes (SC & FL) with KY +50 ypg & +12.5 ppg while VU is -245 ypg and -16.5 ppg. KY has failed to cover their L/8 as HF but the last cover was also LTH and Vandy is 1-10 ATS vs SEC foes. The 'Cats are fresh off a bye while Vandy is playing their 8th straight week.

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**TEMPLE by 6 over Cincinnati** - The away team is on a 7-1 ATS run in the series. Cincy enters fresh off a bye & ranked for the 1st time s'12. TU had a 418-284 yd edge at Navy LW, took the lead for good early 4Q & held Navy to 1 tlt yd it's L/2 drives. The Owls were without leading rusher Ryquell Armstead (ankle, CS). TU is all'g 207 rush ypg over their L/4 gms, but just 3.9 ypc! Cincy is avg 256 (5.3) rush ypg led by the powerful running of Michael Warren. Both rank in the top 10 on D in yds/pl. TU has a bye on deck & is 8-4 as a HF. Both HC's preach physicality & that's exactly what this game will feature.

**UCf by 13 over EAST CAROLINA** - It's homecoming in Greenville. UCF is on a 7-2 ATS series run, incl 3-1 at EC. Both have bye's on deck. UCF is on the 2nd of B2B away gms, while EC is home for the 3rd time in 4 wks. After showing improvement their F/4 gms, EC enters off B2B double-digit losses. LW vs Hou, however, they were only out'd 222-204 & finished -4 TO's. EC has held 3 of their L/4 foes to ssn lows in yds! UCF enters off an emotional come-from-behind win at Memphis. Trailing by over 2 td's, the Knights kicked a 44 yd fg w/no time left 1H, scored the gm deciding td early 4Q & benefitted from faulty clock management by the Tigers down the stretch. UCF is avg 556 ypg & is #12 FBS avg 104 ypg more than their foes allow, while EC is all'g 351 ypg & is #14 FBS holding foes to 95 ypg less than their avg. We'll call for EC to keep it close.

**SYRACUSE by 3 over North Carolina** - 1st ACC mtg. Cuse is fresh off a bye, having lost 2 straight prior. The Tar Heels gave true frosh QB Cade Fortin his 1st start LW vs VT & he pl'y'd well but left with an inj (CS). NC, no longer susp riddled, held a 262-118 yd edge at HT yet only led 9-7 thanks to an array of mistakes. RB Carter rushed for 165 (9.2) but fumbled at the GL which led to the Hokies' 98/18 pl GW td drive. Syracuse has allowed over 240 rush yds on 3 occasions, including in each of their L/2. NC rushed for 215 vs Miami and 235 vs VT, both over 100 yds more than those teams give up on the ground. NC's OFF is #27, avg 67 ypg more than their foes allow while Cuse's D is #86, all'g 12 ypg more than their foes avg and the Tar Heels have faced the tougher sked (#13 vs #93). NC is 7-3 as an AD and much better than their record indicates.

**IOWA by 17 over Maryland** - It's homecoming in Iowa City. These B10 rivals haven't met since '15. This is Iowa's lone home game in a 6 week span & they have a road trip to PSU on deck. Both enter off blowout wins. Iowa QB Nate Stanley is showing off his NFL talent w/300+ pass yds in 3 of his L/4 gms, including B2B. MD is all'g just 53% completions and has 12 int's. The Terps are avg 245 (6.0) rush ypg, led by the 2 headed attack of Ty Johnson & Anthony McFarland, but Iowa is all'g just 82 (2.7) rush ypg. Iowa is 14-22 as a HF, but MD is 4-7 as an AD. All of Iowa's wins TY have come by double-digits & we'll call for that trend to continue.

**DUKE by 10 over Virginia** - In 1984 we used this game as our first ever free Sept 5★ with UVA winning 38-10 (-4)! UVA has won 3 straight in this series but the home team is 11-5-1 ATS. We picked up a 3★ Key Selection winner on these pages with Duke last week (also 4★ LPS!) in their 28-14 (-3) win at GT. HC Mendenhall picked up his biggest win at UVA by beating Miami last week 16-13 (-6) despite the 'Hoos being outgained by 108 yds and QB Perkins threw for just 92 yds and 3 int's. Perkins will have a tough time getting back on track against Duke's D which holds foes to 86 ypg below their avg (#20). UVA also has a strong D, holding foes to 72 ypg below their avg (#29). Duke has the QB edge with Daniel Jones who has compl'd 68% w/a 8-2 ratio. Duke is 18-12 ATS as a HF while UVA is coming off an emotional win.

**MARSHALL by 5 over Fau** - Marshall won the F/4 mtgs but FAU won last year 30-25 (-7) with HC Kiffin electing to take a safety with :08 left, giving Herd backers a cover. FAU enters fresh off a bye while Marshall picked up a 42-20 (-3) win at ODU. The Herd never trailed but only led 28-20 4Q and added 2 td's in the L/3:05. RB Tyler King had his 2nd consec big effort, rushing for 195 (8.9). FAU has rushed for 309 (6.0) ypg their L/4. Marshall has held every foe to 3.5 ypc or less and is allowing just 104 (3.0) ypg. QB Green has missed the L/2 with an inj (CS) and the Herd could really use him back against FAU's #123 ranked pass eff D. FAU is 0-4 ATS on the road and we feel the Herd's run D, led by LB Chase Hancock, will be the difference.

**Northwestern by 12 over RUTGERS** - It's homecoming in New Brunswick. This will be the 1st mtg as B10 rivals with the last matchup taking place in 1991! NW is travelling for the 2nd time in 3 wks & has UW on deck. RU is home for the 4th time in 5 wks & has a bye on deck. While RU enters off a blowout loss at MD, NW is off an emotional come-from-behind OT win vs a better than their winless record suggests Nebraska. The 'Cats trailed by double-digits on 2 separate occasions 4Q, but scored twice in the L/2:27 capped off by QB Clayton Thorson's gm tying 5 yd td pass w/:12 after driving 99/8pl! With the grad of car leading rusher Justin Jackson & the med retirement of Jeremy Larkin, future NFL'r Thorson has taken control w/300+ yds in 3 of the L/4 gms. NW is 27-41 as chalk & this price seems high for a tm that's won 3 gms by an avg of 6 ppg.

**MASSACHUSETTS by 6 over Coastal Carolina** - UMass will be out for revenge after all'g CC to get their 1st win as an FBS tm LY. The CC OFF has taken a step fwd TY, +78 ypg & +8 ppg from LY. Their D though hasn't improved, all'g 435 ypg & 35 ppg. The UMass OFF is strong under QB Andrew Ford, avg 463 ypg at home (378 ypg away) but the issue is the same for UMass, the D isn't doing their part. They are all'g 500 ypg as well as 45 ppg! CC's strength is running (249 rush ypg) & they'll lean on that, while Ford will try to win the gm through the air (CC #110 PDR). This gm could come down to ST's, where UMass (#83 vs #114) has the edge. CC is also just 2-7 SU on the road & UMass is fresh off a bye & is 7-4 as a HF.

**ARMY by 13 over Miami** - Miami has won 3 straight meeting incl a 35-28 win as a 2 pt HD when they last met in 2011. MU is playing an 8th straight week while Army had a bye 2 wks ago. Army has a 9 game home streak & have covered both HG's TY as a HF. Since losing to a now 5-1 Duke in the opener, the Knights defense has held their other 5 foes to at least 13.2 ppg below their ssn average holding both Oklahoma & Buffalo to season low. They put up a ssn high 52 pts vs San Jose ST LW & beat MAC foe Buffalo 42-13 as a 7' pt AD prior to their bye wk. The RedHawks are 3-1 SU & 4-0 ATS in conf play but 0-3 SU & ATS in non-conf gms TY losing by an avg 17 ypg. Miami's next 3 gms are against MAC East leading Buffalo, MAC East Favorite Ohio & MAC West leader NIU, so will want to get out of this game healthy. Look for Army to take care of business here.

**Michigan by 9 over MICHIGAN ST** - MSU has dominated their 'big brother' of late, winning 8 of 10 SU & 10-0 ATS. UM did win 32-25 (-25) their LTH in '16 & has a bye on deck. UM never trailed in their dominant 38-13 win vs Wiscy LW, finishing w/ 21-11 FD & 444-283 yd edges incl 320 (6.7) rush! Following their double-digit home loss vs NW, MSU HC Dantonio does what he does best & pulled off another outright upset, this time at PSU, giving us another 2★ winner on these pages (91-48-1 L5Y) & an outright upset win in our 'Big Dog Pkg' (3 outright upset winners LW!) Trailing by 3, Sparty drove 76/8pl & QB Brian Lewerke threw the GW 25 yd td pass w/:19 left. MSU had a 25-14 FD edge. This should be a low scoring affair as UM is all'g 238 ypg & is #1 FBS holding foes to 211 ypg below their avg, while MSU is all'g 62 (2.3) rush ypg & is holding foes to 74 ypg below their avg. HC Harbaugh is putting the critics to rest & will continue to do so.

**Ohio St by 20 over PURDUE** - These B10 rivals haven't met s/13. PU is on a 5-2 ATS series run at home. OSU has a bye on deck. This is PU's lone home game in a 5 wk stretch. After st/g '18 winless their F/3 gms, PU has won 3 str & enters off their best gm of the ssn, blowing out IL on the road by 39 pts, winning our top LPS total on the UNDER (3-0 weekend & totals GOM going this wknd)! Since taking over full-time vs Mizzou, QB David Blough is avg 393 pass ypg (68%, 10-2 ratio)! While OSU remains undefeated, they slept-walked their way to a closer than expected 16 pt win vs Minny LW. The Buckeyes avg 557 ypg & lead the nation avg 183 ypg more than their foes allow, but have been victimized big plays & PU's Rondale Moore is 1 of the most electrifying true frosh in the nation w/40+ yd gains in every gm he's played! OSU has finished #7, 5, 1 & 1 in our PDR the L4Y, but is #43 TY. PU is 6-20 as a HD & we'll back the Buckeyes laying less than 2 td's.

**Alabama by 31 over TENNESSEE** - It's the Third Saturday in October and HC Pruitt faces his former employer for the first time. HC Saban is never kind to his former asst's, going 13-0 and winning those by 26.6 ppg. Tenn had lost their L/15 games vs SEC West foes until last week when the Vols ended their 11 game SEC losing streak and 15 gm losing streak vs SEC West foes by beating Auburn 30-24 as more than a 2 td dog (1 of 3 outright Big Dog Winners last week, just \$9, call 1-800-654-3448). Bama comes off a 39-10 (-28) win over Mizzou but the big news was QB Tagovailoa had to leave with a knee inj though HC Saban says he could have returned. QB Guarantano threw for a car high 328 LW vs Aub but faces our #1 pass eff D. The Vols have allowed over 200 rush yds in 2 of their 3 SEC games. Tenn is 0-4 as a HD while Bama is 25-17 as AF.

**BALL ST by 3 over Eastern Michigan** - The visitor is 10-4 ATS. LY Ball St was without QB Neal & RB Gilbert. They never led & after getting within 28-14 late 2Q allowed 28 unanswered in a 56-14 loss (+24) for EM's largest MOV (42 pt) in their 59 mtgs. TY Ball St lost to NIU 24-16 as a 3 pt HD the week after EM lost to NIU 26-23 in OT as a 3' pt HF. Both teams are off close upset wins. Ball St kicked a GW FG with :47 left to beat CM 24-23 as a 2' pt AD. EM almost blew a 21-0 1Q lead over Toledo as they had to stop UT's 2 pt conv attempt w/:20 left for a 28-26 win as a 1'5 pt HD. Ball St has the off edge (#77-#105), while EM has the Edge on D (#68-#104). Ball St is 2-1 SU & ATS in MAC play, while EM IS 1-3 SU & 2-2 ATS. In what should be a close game, we will side with the underdog home team.

**Akron by 6 over KENT ST** - Rivalry game for the "Wagon Wheel" Trophy series is tied at 23-23-1. UA has won 3 straight but was just 1-2 ATS. LY KS only trailed 10-7 late 2Q but allowed a td w/:18 left then gave up a FR td on final play of half to trail 24-7 and lost 24-14 as a 15 pt AD. Both teams are off disappointing losses as 11 pt AD's. Akron was outgained by 200 yds by Buffalo, being outscored 14-0 in the 2H in a 24-6 loss. While KS scored in the 2H, it was a garbage td w/:36 left as they were outgained by 230 yds in a 31-6 loss at Miami. The Zips lost to Miami the wk prior 41-17 as a 5 pt HF (outgained by 163 yds). While both teams have wins over FCS foes, Akron did beat Northwestern 39-34 thanks to the defense (3 def td's). It is that defense, that has us siding with the Zip (#84-#108 edge) in this rivalry.

**Penn St by 17 over INDIANA** - These schools have met each of the L3Y & PSU is 3-0 SU/ATS, winning by an avg of 23 ppg & covering by an avg of 12 ppg. This may be just the type of opponent PSU needs after dropping B2B gms despite holding 4Q leads in each. After dropping B2B gms LY also to OSU & MSU, PSU followed up with a 29 pt win over Rutgers. While IU isn't in nearly the same category as RU, they've been victimized thru the air the L/2 wks, all'g 70% completions w/a 12-3 ratio! PSU QB Trace McSorley should improve his 54% completions here. PSU does have Iowa on deck, but is 7-2 as an AF, while IU is 2-6 as a HD.

**WISCONSIN by 23 over Illinois** - It's homecoming in Madison. It's no surprise IL is 0-8 SU vs ranked foes under HC Smith, but worth noting the avg score is 44-13. IL is travelling for the 2nd time in 3 wks, while UW has a trip to NW on deck. Both enter off blowout losses as UW was held to a ssn low 283 yds vs the nations #1 defense & IL is all'g 505 ypg while ranking #124 FBS all'g 118 ypg more than their foes avg! The last time UW was held to under 300 yds in a reg ssn gm was '16 (also vs UM) & they rebounded the following wk w/450 yds vs OSU! Normally efficient QB Alex Hornibrook will bounce back vs IL's #101 PDR, but we'll call for IL to keep it closer than expected.

**LOUISIANA TECH by 20 over Utep** - LT is 5-0 SU/3-2 ATS vs UTEP in CUSA meetings. The Miners have lost 18 straight but seem to be improving under HC Dimel. They enter fresh off a bye after nearly upsetting N Texas and are +42 ypg in their L/3. Last week LT was at UTSA and we used the Bulldogs as both our Early Bird POW (Button #9 Comp on Monday's, 195-107 (65%)) and a 4★ LPS and LT gave us an easy 31-3 (-11) winner. UTEP's OFF looked much better with QB Metz under center but QB Locksley could return off an inj (CS). Both tms ply'd N Texas and UTSA, with LT +15 ppg and +15 ypg while UTEP is -6 ppg and +4 ypg. UTEP has covered 3 of their L/4 so we will call for them to stay within 3 td's.

**FIU by 20 over Rice** - FIU won this game last year 13-7 (+2), stopping Rice at the FIU9 to end the gm. Rice has scored just 3 points and avg 204 ypg in their L/2, losses to UTSA & UAB. Last week vs the Blazers, Rice trailed 42-0 3Q and was outgained by 296 yards. FIU pulled out a 24-21 (-2) home win over Middle Tenn last week. The Panthers held +52 yd edge, although QB Stockstill did get hurt

in the 2Q and MT's backup threw an int in the EZ on their final poss. FIU is +73 ypg in CUSA play and WR Worton (Florida transfer) had 113 LW vs MT. Rice is -185 vs CSUA foes. The Panthers are 3-0 ATS at home this year. Rice is on a 6-13 ATS run.

**APPALACHIAN ST by 17 over Louisiana** - App St has dominated this series, winning the 4 previous mtgs by a combined score of 150-37 (avg MOV is 28 ppg). Last ssn this gm was also in Boone and App St got out to a 35-7 HT lead and won 63-14 (outgained LA 608-369). App St most recent game was last Tues, so they have had extra time to get ready for this gm. App St star RB Jalin Moore (400 yds, 6 td) is OFY after suffering an severe ankle inj last gm. LA is off a dominant 66-38 win at home against NMSt and have won 2 straight thanks to their stellar run game (248 ypg, 3 players with 275+ rush yds). However, App St is limiting teams to 107 rush ypg and boasts a top-10 defense that is holding tms to 110 ypg under their ssn avg.

**ARKANSAS by 14 over Tulsa** - It's homecoming in Fayetteville. This is the 73rd all-time mtg, but the 1st s/12. Ark is in an SEC sandwich with Vandy on deck. While the Hogs enter on a 6 gm slide, they're much better than their record indicates & never trailed ATS vs Ole Miss LW, leading by as many as 17 pts as we cashed yet another 5★ winner as part of a winning Saturday that saw our LPS's finish 8-1! (lone loss on last second fg). TU is travelling for the 2nd time in 3 wks & is off an emotional home loss to USF. Up 24-10 mid 4Q, TU all'd 15 straight pts including the GW 22 yd fg w/:02 left. Look for a physical ground & pound type of gm, but Ark RB Rakeem Boyd is a ? (back, CS) & QB Ty Storey also left LW's gm after taking a vicious sideline hit. TU is 14-5 as an AD.

**Georgia Southern by 6 over NEW MEXICO ST** - GS leads this series 3-1 SU, but NMSt actually got their lone win in this series last ssn and are 4-0 ATS in the series. The Aggies held the Eagles to 265 total yds and scored 2 TD's in the final quarter to win 35-27. GS is off of a narrow 15-13 win at home over TXSt where they gained just 164 rush yds (93 below their ssn avg) and 215 total yds. NMSt is off of a blowout 66-38 loss to Louisiana where they gave up 759 total yds incl 344 on the ground. As we all know GS is a strong running team and will certainly attack the NMSt run defense that is allowing 260 rush ypg. GS is on a 7-2 ATS run while NMSt is just 4-8 ATS and is 2-4 as a HD. With the Eagles having to travel out West & battle the altitude, we'll call for the Aggies to keep this game closer than expected.

**Utah St by 20 over WYOMING** - Utah St is 4-2 SU and ATS the last 6 gms in the series, but the home team is 6-2 SU and ATS over their L/8 mtgs. Last ssn Utah St actually led 23-16 in the 4Q, but the Cow-boys rallied and scored the games final 12 pts and won 28-23. The Aggies also committed 5 TO's in last ssn's contest. Both teams have faced NMSt already this ssn and both won, but Utah St had the much more dominant game, winning 60-13 over NMSt (489-280 yd edge, +3 TO's). This ssn Utah St's offense has been explosive (479 ypg and 52 ppg) and their defense has shut teams down (366 ypg, 24 ppg). On the other hand, Wyoming's offense has failed to score more than 20 pts since their opener, and are gaining just 282 ypg. Utah St is 4-2-1 ATS in their L/7 MW gms while Wyoming is just 2-4 in their L/6 gms as a home dog. The Aggies appear to be the class of the MW and we like them to pick up the road win here.

**Fresno St by 10 over NEW MEXICO** - Fresno is 4-0 SU in this series since joining the MW and are beating the Lobos by nearly 27 ppg. Last ssn these teams met and Fresno won easily 38-0 (526-322 yd edge) and held NM to just 109 rush yds (126 yds below ssn avg) and 2-14 on 3rd down. The Bulldogs have hung their hat on defense all ssn, allowing just 301 ypg and 14 ppg. On the ssn Fresno is holding foes to 78 yds below their ssn avg. Meanwhile NM is 3-3 SU this ssn, but have not won B2B gms and held inconsistent at times. In their 3 wins they are avg'g 51 ppg and in their 3 losses are avg'g just 25 ppg.

**Western Michigan by 10 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN** - Battle for the Cannon rivalry, 89th all-time mtg. LY WM was in their 1st gm after losing st'g QB Wassink. They led 28-14 into the 4Q but allowed 21 unanswered to lose 35-28 as a 3' pt HF. WM has still won 5 of the L/7 SU & the visitor has covered 6 straight. CM's only win TY is 17-5 win over FCS Maine & they are 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS in MAC play with their only cover as a 14 pt AD vs NIU. After 2 losses to Power 5 tms, WM has won 5 straight but while they are 3-0 SU in MAC play they are 0-3 ATS in those gms. While CM has a #79-#99 defensive edge, WM has a huge #29-#122 offensive edge. WM was down to BG 21-7 at HT but stormed back with 35 2H pts, thanks to 199 combined rush yds by RB's Bogan & Bellamy. CM could not hold onto a 20-7 HT lead as they allowed Ball St to kick the GW fg w/:47 left in a 24-23 loss as a 2' pt HF. While WM has a big game vs Toledo on deck this is a rivalry game with bowl eligibility as a bonus if they win, so look for WM to take care od business here.

**UCLA by 7 over Arizona** - After a tough schedule to start the Chip Kelly campaign that included losses to 4 teams that were part of LW's Top 25, the Bruins have played much better the past 2 weeks following a 7 pt loss at home against the Huskies and a blowout win in Berkeley where their defense forced 5 TO's and held Cal to 102 yds under their ssn avg. The Wildcats had no answer for the Utes LW in SLC (trailed 35-3 in 3Q) with star QB Tate being sidelined early on with an ankle injury (CS here). In LY's matchup in the desert, QB Khalil Tate rushed for 230 yds in the 17 pt upset victory (UCLA -4 TO's). With the Bruins covering 3 of their past 4 P12 HG's and the Wildcats going 3-10-1 if a conf AF, we'll call for UCLA to rattle off their 2nd consec win after their rocky start.

## NAVY +12' over Houston

It's homecoming in Annapolis. The home tm is 3-0 ATS as AAC rivals. UH is on the 2nd of B2B away gms & this is their 1st time seeing the option TY. In fact this will be the total opposite in terms of style after defending 63 pass att's in their 22 pt win at EC LW. While the Cougars benefitted from +4 TO's LW & were out FD'd 27-18, 158 of the 415 yds they all'd came on 4Q gbg td drives. Navy enters on a 3 gm slide & hasn't dropped 4 in a row s/11. They changed QB's LW vs Temple w/Malcolm Perry moving to SB & Garret Lewis under center, but failed to hold onto a double-digit 2H lead all'g 17 unanswered. The loss was just their 2nd at home in the reg ssn the L3Y! UH is 2-8 as an AF, while the Middies are 5-1-1 as a HD. Navy does have Notre Dame on deck, but needs to get back on track & HC Niumatalolo will pull out all the tricks here & we'll call for the outright upset making this our Underdog POW!

**WASHINGTON ST by 3 over Oregon** - Following 2 years of embarrassing losses to the Huskies in which they were outscored by a 108-24 margin, the Ducks earned some much-needed revenge LW in Eugene to keep their hopes of claiming the P12 North alive in the OT win (UW key missed FG at end of regulation). Oregon now ventures North to take on a well-rested Cougars squad that has delivered 3 straight in this series including a 33-10 victory (-3) LY in Eugene where they held the Ducks to just 277 yds of offense (top 2 QB's out for Oregon). With the Ducks on just a 2-8 ATS run in P12 road games and potentially suffering a hangover from LW's win, we'll go ahead and call for the mild upset in the Palouse this weekend with the Cougars winning 10 consec games at home overall (7-3 ATS) heading in.

**WASHINGTON by 21 over Colorado** - After an OT loss LW in Eugene where they finished with a 437-379 yd edge, the Huskies return to Seattle looking to get back on track against an opponent that they should have quite a bit of confidence against. Washington has knocked off Colorado in 9 straight (22 pt avg MOV) including a 37-10 victory (-11) LY in Boulder. The Buffaloes meanwhile head into the Pacific NW following their 1st defeat of the '18 campaign against the Trojans in a game that we cashed a 3★ Totals Winner on the Under 57.5 (game featured just 33 FD's & 599 tt yds!). With Washington at home for the only time in a 4-week span and coming out victorious in each of their past 11 Husky Stadium matchups by 28 ppg, it appears that a 2nd consec loss for the Buffaloes is on the horizon.

**California by 4 over OREGON ST** - Following a 2nd straight TO filled game for the Bears where they coughed the ball up on 5 more occasions (4 the week prior) in the 30 pt loss to UCLA, Cal heads up North to take on an OSU team that's well-rested following their bye week. In LY's matchup in Berkeley, Cal finished with 32-17 FD and 475-299 yd edges in the 37-23 win (-7). While the Bears have the talent to get the victory in Corvallis against a Beavers squad that's dropped 6 consec P12 HG's by 16 ppg, laying too many points could be a risky venture as Cal has dropped 14 straight conf AG's overall including just a 3-11 ATS mark in that span.

**FLORIDA ST by 15 over Wake Forest** - It's HC in Tallahassee. FSU has won 6 straight but WF has covered the L/2 with LY ending in a push after the 'Noles got a 40 yd WG td with :53 left. Both teams enter much needed byes. FSU has dealt with injuries and poor performances on the OL which has resulted in just 93 (2.7) ypg rush but WF allows 236 (5.9) and off to the bye gave up a ridiculous 471 rush and 11.8 ypc in a 63-3 loss to Clemson. WF has the edge on OFF but this is true frosh QB Hartman's 1st ACC road start as the Deacons haven't been on the road since Sept 1st! The 'Noles held Miami to a ssn low 306 yds and led by 20 pts in the 2H. WF is 10-4 as an AD but we expect FSU to be healthier and improved over their bye.

**OHIO by 20 over Bowling Green** - LY's mtg had 8 lead changes but OU never trailed in the 4Q, leading 41-23 w/11:02 left as a 10 pt AF. While the Bobcats have won 2 in a row SU, LY was their only cover the L/7 mtgs. OU is off a 24-21 loss at NIU, but cov'd as our Underdog POW on these pages! They do have a short wk ahead with a Thurs gm on deck, while BG has 10 days off until a Tues game. The Bobcats have a huge coaching edge as HC Solich won his 100th game here 2 wks ago, while after blowing a 21-7 HT lead LW, BG let go of HC Jinks and promoted DC Carl Pelini, who was previous the HC at FAU. After LW's MAC loss, the Bobcats are chasing Buffalo in the MAC East race and can not look past any MAC game. Ohio has a big offensive edge (#64-#106) and with BG reshuffling responsibilities look the Bobcats to take care of business here.

**ULM by 8 over Texas St** - As Sun Belt foes ULM leads this series 3-2 SU and have won the last 2 gms SU by an avg of 16 ppg. Last year TXSt jumped out to a 20-19 1Q lead, but ULM would outscore TXSt the rest of the way 26-7 and won 45-27 behind QB Evans' 433 yd, 3 TD day. TXSt is off of a close loss to Georgia Southern 15-13 (failed 2-pt conv would have tied gm) where they outgained the Eagles 242-215. ULM got their offense back on track vs CC last week, gaining 466 yds and putting up 45 pts. While the ULM defense all'd 439 yds, they forced 3 TO's in the win. While ULM is just 5-8 SU at home vs SBC foes s/ 2015, TXSt is just 1-11 SU (4-8 ATS) in SBC road games in that same span. We'll lean slightly with the home team after their strong performance last week.

**NEBRASKA by 4 over Minnesota** - The \$5 Bits of Broken Chair Trophy is on the line. The host has won & covered each of the L2Y. NU is 0-6 SU for the 1st time in schl history & after all'g a 4Q double-digit lead evaporate LW at NW, HC Scott Frost looked shell-shocked & demoralized afterward. MN enters on a 3 gm slide, but after being held to 90 (2.5) rush ypg their prior 2 gms, gained confidence after rushing for 178 (5.4) LW at OSU & trailed by less than a td 4Q! NU is much better than their record indicates & their OFF which is avg 441 ypg is #15 FBS avg 99 ypg more than their foes allow & has finished with the most yds all'd by each of their L/2 foes. Despite MN gaining confidence, they're on the 2nd of B2B away games & we'll call for the Huskers to pick up their 1st win of the season.

**USF by 28 over Connecticut** - It's homecoming in Tampa. The dog in this series is 8-1 ATS. USF is home for the lone time in a 5 wk span & enters off an emotional win at Tulsa, their 4th game TY where they won despite being down double-digits in the 4Q. The Bulls did finish w/487-299 yd & 26-16 FD edges & hit the GW 22 yd fg w/:02 left. They won't find themselves in that predicament here as UConn is arguably the worst tm in the FBS & there's no argument they have the worst defense in the nation as they're all'g their foes 211 ypg more than their avg and 322 (7.8) rush ypg. USF is avg 487 ypg, led by Florida transfer RB Jordan Cronkrite, who is avg 180 (8.5) rush ypg his L/4 gms. UConn enters fresh off a bye & USF has failed to look dominant so we'll take the pts.

**TULANE by 10 over Smu** - SMU has covered 4 of the L/5 mtgs in New Orleans. Both enter fresh off a bye. SMU is all'g 223 (4.5) rush ypg vs FBS foes, but did defend the Navy option a few wks ago & has an extra wk of prep. While not a true 'revenge' gm, TU was 1 win away from bowl elig into LY's finale & SMU stopped them inches short of the GW td on the final play. The Ponies repl'd QB Ben Hicks with HC Dykes recruit true frosh William Brown, who is a running threat, but Hicks has come in when SMU wants to attack thru the air. SMU is avg just 292 ypg vs FBS foes. TU is on a 6-1 ATS run vs FBS foes at home, while SMU is 2-5 ATS away.

**CLEMSON by 18 over NC State** - This game likely decides the ACC Atlantic. Clemson has won 6 straight but NCSt has covered 3 of the L/4 in this series. The home team is 6-15 ATS but has covered 3 of the L/5. Both teams enter off byes. QB Finley has been excellent, throwing for 324 ypg, compl'g 70% w/a 10-3 ratio but the story for NCSt has been the excellent play of both their OL and DL. NCSt has allowed just 2 sks, and the run game is improving, but they've yet to see a DL clique like Clemson's which brings at least 4 future NFL draft picks. The 'Pack have allowed just 107 (3.7) rush but Clemson brings a potent run game led by Travis Etienne who has topped 100 r straight and vs WF the Tigers had 3 top 100 rush yds! HC Doeren is 6-9-1 as an AD. The Wolfpack is off to an excellent start but Clemson has the edge in the trenches and QB Lawrence will have success vs our #69 rated pass eff D.

## REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK.....LSU SITUATIONAL PLAY OF THE WEEK.....KENTUCKY SERIES PLAY OF THE WEEK.....WASHINGTON ST

**TEXAS TECH by 20 over Kansas** - It's homecoming in Lubbock. While KU enters fresh off a bye, TT enters on a few extra days rest following their Thursday night 17-14 win at TCU. TT is on a 5-2-1 ATS series run & has won the L/2 meetings by a comb'd score of 120-38! KU fired their OC during the bye & HC Beatty will call the plays. The Jayhawks have yet to settle on a sf'g QB as Peyton Bender st'd the F/4 gms & Carter Stanley the last. TT has st'd 3 different QB's due to inj with Jett Duffey st'g at TCU. While Duffey is compl 60%, he has just a 2-4 ratio & is more dangerous as a runner. KU is all'g 508 ypg & 208 (5.0) rush ypg in B12 play & while you normally think of TT as a pass happy bunch, their nearly 50/50 in rush/pass plays TY. TT is 6-2 as a HF, while KU is 21-36-2 as an AD.

**SOUTHERN MISS by 20 over Utsa** - SM is 3-1 ATS in this series. The last 2 meetings have resulted in upsets. LY SM was +12' and led 31-23 4Q. UTSA scored late but failed a 2 pt conv. SM lost to N Texas 30-7 (+8) last week. They only trailed 10-7 at half (-31 yds) and 16-7 to start the 4Q. Last week we recognized that UTSA was off a deceiving 3 game win streak vs tms that were 0-14 vs FBS foes. We went against the RoadRunners and they were dominated just as we thought, 31-3 (+11) at home vs LT. UTSA has yet to top 300 yds on OFF and come in dead last in FBS, putting up 162 ypg less than their foes allow. SM is #45 on D, holding foes to 54 ypg below their avg. QB Abraham has hit 71% with a 12-6 ratio and will look to take advantage of our #120 pass eff D. UTSA is on a 1-10 ATS run, 0-7 ATS off a SU loss.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 21 over Charlotte** - MT is 3-0 SU/ATS vs Charlotte. The Blue Raiders needed a win last week vs FIU to keep them firmly in the driver's seat of CUSA East. They lost QB Stockstill 2Q (inj'd, CS) and bkp QB Asher threw an int in the EZ on MT's final pass, resulting in a 24-21 (+2) loss. UC was one of our 3 Big Dog outright winners last week, upsetting WKU 40-14. The score was only 9-7 at half but UC dominated the 2H with WKU adding a gbg time td. The 49ers finished with +188 yd edge. RB Lemay rushed for 121 (7.1). UC is #15 on , holding foes to 96 ypg below their avg. MT is only #113 on OFF, avg 59 ypg less than their foes allow but most of the damage came vs 2 SEC foes (#59 sked). Charlotte is #123 on OFF, avg 80 ypg less than their foes avg despite having ply'd no P5 teams (#125 sked). MT is +21.6 ppg the L2Y in home wins. UC is 2-7 ATS on the road.

**Old Dominion by 3 over WKU** - Both of these teams enter with just 1 win in the midst of disappointing seasons. WKU trailed 9-7 at half last week but lost 40-14 (-9) at Charlotte while getting outgained by 188 yds. ODU trailed 20-0 (-3') 4Q then allowed 2 late td's vs Marshall and were only outgained by 99 yds. The Monarchs got 296 pass yds from QB LaRussa. WKU is -36 ypg on the season and still are unsettled at QB with both Duncan and Shanley getting snaps. ODU was close in the 4Q against Marshall FIU, and FAU, and also beat VT. WKU's close losses came vs FCS Maine, L'ville, and Marshall. This is a tossup so we will take the underdog to pull the upset against a Toppers squad that is 2-8 as a fav.

**LSU by 11 over Mississippi St** - LSU is out for legit revenge after getting smacked down 37-7 (-7). The Tigers were in a great spot as a home dog last week and pounded Georgia 36-16 (+7). LSU rushed for 275 (5.4) and moved to 16-0 under HC Orgeron when they have a 100 yd rusher (Edwards-Helaire 145, 7.6). The Tigers allows just 120 rush ypg (3.5) and held UGA to a ssn low 322 yds. Miss St enters off a bye, having beat Auburn the weak prior. QB Fitzgerald is completing 50% w/a 4-3 ratio and has rushed for 513 (5.2). The Bulldogs are #8 on D, holding foes to 118 ypg below their avg. LSU has a bye on deck. This is a night game in Death Valley and MSU is 0-3 as an AD while HC Orgeron is 14-4 ATS vs SEC foes

**Usc by 1 over UTAH** - The Trojans earned a rare spread victory LW at home against the Buffaloes where they jumped out to a 28-7 4Q lead in the eventual 11 pt win (334-265 yd edge, 3★ LP Winner on UNDER 57.5!). The Utes meanwhile had no problem handling the Wildcats last Friday at home with a 495-318 yd edge in the 32-pt win. In LY's trip to the Coliseum, the Trojans erased a 21-7 HT deficit in the eventual 1 pt victory (USC 532-436 yd edge).

**SAN DIEGO ST by 17 over San Jose St** - SDSt is 5-0 ATS and SU in the last 5 mtgs vs SJSt. In their 4 previous gms the Aztecs are outscoring the Spartans 162-24 (avg MOV 34.5 ppg). SDSt scored a TD with 6 min left 4Q to escape with a 21-17 home win over Air Force, while SJSt all'd 341 rush yds to Army and were throttled 52-3 (SJSt gained just 171 tt yds). SDSt has thrived as a favorite in MW play, going 26-13 s/2012, while SJSt 10-15-1 as a MW underdog s/2013. This could very well be a game where SDSt gets their run game back on track (just 84 rsh yds vs AF) as the Spartans allow 183 rush ypg (280 rush ypg all'd past 2 weeks). SDSt has another strong defense (309 ypg all'd, 19 ppg all'd) under HC Rocky Long and will be going up against an offense avg'g just 32 rush ypg and 19 ppg this ssn against FBS foes (SDSt holds tms to just 87 rush ypg this ssn). Everything points to another SDSt victory in this one and we like the home favorite.

**HAWAII by 1 over Nevada** - Nevada is 6-1 SU (5-2 ATS) in this series. UH dropped just their 2nd gm LW at BYU as Cole McDonald returned to complete just 58% for 248 yds. Meanwhile Nevada is off just a 4-pt loss at home to Boise, where Gangi came back & passed for 304 yds and the defense forced 4 TO's held them to just 299 pass yds. Last ssn Nev picked up their first win of the year in this game as the Wolf Pack gained 566 yds and forced a pair of TO's in a 35-21 win. UH is just 4-10 SU in MW home gms s/2015 while Nevada is just 3/10 SU in MW road gms in that same span. UH has already surpassed expectations this ssn by reaching 6 wins, but their high octance pass offense has come back to earth the past few weeks and with their poor home record in MW play, we think this will be close one and we'll take a slight lean with the underdog.

**TUESDAY October 23RD:**

**Troy at SOUTH ALABAMA** - This series is tied 3-3, but SALa has actually won 3 of the L/4 gms SU. Troy will be out for revenge in this game as last ssn the Trojans were off a huge upset of LSU in Death Valley and SALa jumped out to a 19-0 lead and wound up winning 19-8 (Troy 4Q TD w/ 6 min left). Troy's offense was held to just 293 yds last week in their loss at Liberty as they are working in bkp QB Smith after Kaleb Barker was inj'd vs GST and is now OFY. SALa picked up a 45-7 win against FCS Alabama St, but are 1-5 SU against FBS foes this ssn. Troy will look to get their run game going against a SALa squad that is all'g 221 rush ypg this ssn. Troy is 5-3 as a road favorite in SBC play s/2016 while SALa is 6-13 SU in SBC play in that same span. Both teams will be off of a bye in this one, so rest will not be an issue for either side.



**KEY SELECTIONS**

**4★ Dallas over WASHINGTON** - Following a 33 pt blowout home victory LW against the Jaguars (378-204 yd edge) where QB Prescott threw for 2 TD's while rushing for a career-best 82 rush yds, the Cowboys head up to D.C. where they've had excellent success with 5 consec victories (4-1 ATS) by 10 ppg (swept the Redskins in each of the past 2 years). After an embarrassing performance on MNF against the Saints where they allowed 43 pts and 447 yds, the Redskins jumped out to a 17-0 home lead against the Panthers in the eventual 6 pt victory (WAS 350-288 yd deficit, +3 TO's). With WAS on just a 1-6 ATS run inside of the NFC East and the Cowboys a polar opposite 6-1 ATS vs DIV foes, we'll ride with the recent trends in this one and call for the outright upset.

**FORECAST: DALLAS by 6**

**3★ Houston over JACKSONVILLE** - Following a pair of road matchups against the Chiefs (30-14 loss) and the Cowboys (40-7 loss, 378-204 yd disadvantage) along with a trip to London on deck, the Jaguars play host to a Texans squad that they swept by a combined 74-14 score a season ago. The Texans do head into this meeting following their 3rd consec win LW at home against the Bills thanks to a dominating defensive effort (3★ LP Winner on Under 40!) that included allowing just 229 yds and forcing 3 TO's (GW 28-yd IR TD w/1:23 left). While HOU has failed to cover 8 of their L/10 against DIV foes heading in, the Jaguars 0-5 SU mark (12 pt avg margin of defeat, 1-3-1 ATS) prior to heading across the pond has us calling for the outright upset.

**FORECAST: HOUSTON by 3**

**OTHER SELECTIONS**

**2★ CHICAGO over New England** - Rematch of Super Bowl XX where the Bears shuffled their way to a 46-10 victory. Since that 1985 ssn matchup the Bears have made just one other trip ('06 loss to IND) while the Patriots have ventured into the "Big Game" on 9 occasions including 5 victories. Following an OT loss LW in Miami where they blew a 21-10 lead in the 2H (all'd 246 yds over ssn avg!), the Bears are sitting at 3-2 and a half game up in the NFC North standings. Meanwhile, the Patriots survived a shootout LW at home against the Chiefs (GW 28-yd FG on final play) in a game that featured 83 pts and nearly 1,000 tll yds. Although the Patriots are on a 12-4 ATS run overall heading into CHI, we like the Bears to earn the narrow win in this one as not only are they 4-1 ATS against the AFC dating back to LY, but they're also on an 8-1-1 spread run as a HD including 5 outright upsets in that span.

**FORECAST: CHICAGO by 3**

**OTHER PLAYS**

**Denver at ARIZONA - Thursday** - It's déjà vu all over again for the Broncos as following their 2nd 2-0 start in as many years, the bottom has fallen out with losses in each of the past 4 contests including a 3 pt loss to the Rams LW in Mile High where RB Gurley became the 2nd player in as many wks (NYJ RB Crowell) to rush for 200+ yds against a once mighty DEN defense. While the Cardinals were able to earn their 1st victory a few weeks back against the 49ers (+5 TO's), their winning ways were short-lived with a 27-17 defeat in MIN (ARZ outgained 411-269). With both teams in play-against mode at the moment with DEN 4-11-1 ATS vs NDIV foes and ARZ failing to cover 8 of their past 12 against the AFC, we'll have to dig a little further before determining which way we decide to lean.

**† LA Chargers by 7 over Tennessee** - London. First visit across the pond for the Titans as they come into action sitting at 3-3 on the year following a 21-0 shutout loss LW at home against BAL (held to just 7 FD's & 106 yds). While the Chargers have made one prior trip to England, it was a decade ago where they dropped a 5 pt contest against the Saints as 3 pt chalk. The Chargers have now rattled off 4 consec wins following their blowout of the Browns in CLE where they had a 449-317 yd edge. In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Chargers claimed a 43-35 win (-4) in a game that featured nearly 900 tll yds. With the Titans being held without a TD in 3 of their past 4 contests and the Chargers on a 4-1 ATS run away from home, we'll ride with the clearly stronger offense that's ranked in the Top 10 in both scoring and total yards heading in.

**Cleveland by 1 over TAMPA BAY** - Following their worst effort of the ssn LW at home against the Chargers in a 38-14 defeat (LAC 449-317 yd edge), the Browns head South to take on a Bucs squad that's clearly struggling since their 2-0 start with 3 consec defeats including a 5 pt loss LW against the Falcons (3.5★ Top LP Winner on ATL) with Winston back under center as the starter (30-41 for 395 yds & 4-2 ratio). While CLE entered the year having dropped 9 in a row both SU & ATS against the NFC, they nearly pulled the outright upset inside of the Superdome against the Saints had it not been for some ST lapses (21-18 defeat as a 9' pt dog). With the Browns having covered 5 of their L/7 coming in and the Bucs just 3-10 ATS as a HF, we'll ride with CLE here as they're still one of the most improved teams in the league despite LW's performance.

**Detroit by 7 over MIAMI** - While things looked bleak early on in with losses to the Jets and 49ers, the Lions have turned around their ssn with victories in 2 of their past 3 matchups (at home vs NE & GB). They now head to South Beach with extra rest after their early bye wk to take on a MIA squad that found a way to get past the Bears LW despite QB Tannehill missing the game with injury (bkp Osweiler 28-44 for 380 yds & 3-2 ratio). With the Dolphins a mediocre team sitting at 4-2 and the fact that the Lions have gone a solid 5-1 ATS after their week off, we'll give the visitor the 7 pt edge in this one.

**PHILADELPHIA by 1 over Carolina** - After an easy 21 pt win last Thursday against the Giants as 3 pt road chalk (QB Wentz 278 yds, 3 TD), the Eagles return home where they've failed to cover their past 2 including an outright upset by MIN a few wks back. The Panthers meanwhile were unable to charge all the way back following an early 17-0 deficit as they would eventually fall by 6 against the Redskins (CAR 350-288 yd edge, -3 TO's). In their Thursday night road trip to Charlotte a season ago, the Eagles erased an early 10-3 deficit en route to a 28-23 upset victory (+3). With PHI on 2-6-1 overall ATS run and the Panthers delivering 7 of their past 9 as a NDIV AD, we like the visitor to keep things close in this matchup.

**INDIANAPOLIS by 9 over Buffalo** - Two of the league's worst teams square off this week as the Bills and Colts have combined for just a 3-9 mark so far in '18. BUF comes in following a close loss LW in HOU (Texans 28-yd IR TD w/1:23 left off bkp QB Peterman who was in for the inj'd Allen). The Colts meanwhile were forced into 4 TO's LW against the Jets in a 42-34 defeat (IND 428-374 yd edge). Last year the Bills and Colts squared off in white-out conditions up in Western NY with BUF escaping with a 13-7 OT victory (21 yd TD run w/1:33 left). While the elements clearly won't affect this matchup inside the dome, we do expect the results to be different this time around with the Colts getting the cover here against a Bills squad that's been held to 13 pts or fewer on 4 occasions so far this year.

**Minnesota by 1 over NY JETS** - The Jets are back at home for a 3rd consec weekend following a pair of impressive performances against the Broncos (34-16 victory) and versus the Colts where they surpassed the 42 pt mark for the 2nd time this ssn (prior to TY the Jets hadn't scored 40 pts since the '12 opener). The Vikings meanwhile head on the road for the 3rd time in 4 wks after a 10 pt home victory over the Cardinals where they held the visitor to just 269 yds. In their most recent meeting back in '14, MIN needed OT to escape as former Viking & Jet QB Teddy Bridgewater connected on an 87 yd TD pass in the extra frame (2nd longest OT TD pass in league history). While the Vikings are 13-4 ATS against the AFC coming in, we expect the Jets to stay within the line in this one as they're on an outstanding 7-1-1 ATS run as a HD including 5 outright upsets during that span.

**BALTIMORE by 1 over New Orleans** - After a memorable MNF performance by QB Brees (became NFL's all-time passing leader) and subsequent bye week, the Saints head to BAL with a 7-1-1 ATS mark after their scheduled week off. The Ravens meanwhile delivered the 21-0 shutout LW in Nashville against the Titans where their defense surrendered just 7 FD's, 106 yds and recorded 11 sks. In their most recent matchup back in '14 on MNF, the underdog Ravens (+3) went into the Superdome and escaped with the 34-27 victory (3rd straight win by BAL in the series). While we'll go ahead and call for the Ravens to earn the win, a minimal 1 pt edge is all that we can offer as BAL is on just a 2-7 ATS run against NFC foes.

**LA Rams by 7 over SAN FRANCISCO** - The Rams were able to keep their '18 record perfect following a 3 pt win LW in the cold of DEN where RB Gurley rushed for a career-best 208 yds & 2 TD. The 49ers meanwhile are sitting at just 1-4 as of presstime with a MNF matchup against the Packers in Lambeau yet to be determined. In LY's ssn finale trip to the Bay Area, the Rams started mainly backups (already clinched playoff spot) in the 24 pt defeat. While this matchup lost some of its luster following the injury to SF QB Garoppolo, keep in mind that the underdog 49ers have gone 10-5 ATS vs NFC West foes including 5 straight spread wins against the Rams (4-1 SU mark).

**Cincinnati at KANSAS CITY - SNF** - Following their 1st loss of the '18 ssn LW in Foxboro where QB Mahomes' 350 yd, 4 TD night wasn't enough to overcome KC's NFL-worst defense that surrendered 43 pts & 500 yds, the Chiefs return home to take on a Bengals team that dropped just their 2nd game of the ssn a week ago at home (3★ LP Winner on PIT) with the Steelers getting the GW 31-yd TD pass w/10 left (PIT 481-275 yd edge). In their most recent matchup inside of "The Jungle" back in '15, the Bengals collected their 4th consec regular ssn win over the Chiefs by a 36-21 score (CIN 14 pt avg MOV during win streak vs KC). While there's a good chance of the scoreboard being lit up this weekend in Arrowhead with KC (#2 at 35.8 ppg) and CIN (#6 at 29.0 ppg) among the NFL's top scoring offenses, it will be interesting to see if the Chiefs can add to their 8-2 ATS mark as a HF against a Bengals squad that's still on a 6-2 spread run coming in. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

**NY Giants at ATLANTA - MNF** - After finally getting back in the win column a week ago against the Bucs while earning a 3.5★ Top Play LP Winner in the process (QB Ryan 31-41 for 354 yds & 3 TD), the Falcons are back at home for a 2nd consec week to take on a struggling Giants squad that fell to 1-5 on the year following their 21 pt home defeat against the Eagles (NYG 401-379 yd edge). In their most recent matchup back in Wk 2 of the '15 season, the Falcons earned the come-from-behind 4 pt road upset (+2) in a game that the Giants led by 10 heading into the 4Q (ATL GW TD w/1:14 left). Despite the 3-9 combined record by these 2 entering this MNF contest, the Falcons do appear to be the stronger of the 2 teams. However, with ATL on just a 1-5 ATS run prior to their bye and the Giants at 5-1 ATS as a NDIV AD, we'll have to wait until closer to kickoff to determine which way to lean.
