WV controls their own destiny in reaching the B12 Title gm & easily cruised past TCU LW, cashing a 4★ LPS (Sat ★ rated plays finished 9-3!). OSU has lost 4 of 5 incl B2B following their emotional 1 pt Bedlam loss as their gm tying 2 pt conv attempt w/1:03 left failed. WV has the D edge & has held 2 of their L/3 foes to ssn lows in ttl yds. WV does have OU on deck, but its 7-3 ATS on the Bx12 road & OSU's pass D has a 20-5 ratio (#79 PDR), which doesn't bode well against WV QB Will Grier (2,618, 70%, 28-7). WV is 7-3 ATS on the B12 road. **FORECAST: West Virginia by 17**

3★ USC over UCLA - After winning 3 straight from '12-'14, UCLA's now dropped 3 in a row against USC incl LY when the Trojans held off a late comeback attempt by the Bruins (28-23 victory, led by 14 in 3Q). UCLA has clearly struggled in the 1st yr under HC Kelly with just a 2-8 overall mark that includes a 3 pt defeat LW in Tempe (TD w/1:57 left). USC meanwhile has yet to claim that elusive 6th win in '18 after blowing a 14 pt lead LW at home against Cal (USC 18-11 FD & 277-207 yg edges). Although the home tm has gone a solid 10-5 ATS coming in, USC's 4-0 ATS run as a P12 AF and needed victory for bowl eligibility has us leaning with the visitor. **FORECAST: USC by 12**

3★ KENTUCKY over Middle Tennessee - MT has already faced 2 SEC foes, getting crushed by both in a 42 pt loss to UGA (down 42-7 at half) and 35-7 at Vandy. RB Snell has now been held under 100 yds in 5 of his L/6 and KY's defense wilted last week, allowing Tenn to put up their 3rd highest yds of the ssn in the 'Cats surprising 17 pt loss. We picked up a 3★ winner on MT last week in their 48-32 (-13) win over UTEP. QB Stockstill threw for 352 and MT held a +158 yg edge. The Blue Raiders have a much more important game vs UAB on deck which will likely decide their CUSA fate so they may be careful with their key players while the 'Cats are angry off their loss to Tenn. KY has failed to cover their L/9 as HF but MT is 7-13 as an AD. **FORECAST: KENTUCKY by 24**

2★ Cincinnati over UCF - College Gameday will be on hand. It's Sr day in Orlando & UCF has been home 4 str wks. The home team had won & covered both mtgs until Cincy was embarrassed LY by 4 td's in a gm called early (late 3Q) due to weather. This gm has HUGE AAC Title gm implications as win by UCF guarantees their appearance, while Cincy will remain in contention with a win. UCF is #9 FBS avg 111 ypg more than their foes allow, but Cincy is #5 FBS on D, holding foes to 129 ypg below their avg. Cincy RB Michael Warren leads a rush attack avg 236 (5.0) ypg, while UCF is all'g 209 (4.5) rush ypg. Cincy is 9-5 as an AD, LY's blowout loss hasn't been forgotten & we'll call for the 'Cats to pull off the outright upset! **FORECAST: Cincinnati by 3**

2★ NEBRASKA over Michigan St - It's Sr day in Lincoln & this is NU's 4th home gm in the L/5 wks. NU is 4-1 ATS as B10 rivals with the last mtg taking place here in '15. While MSU enters off a 20 pt home loss vs OSU, they did hold the Buckeyes to a ssn low 347 yds, however the weather did play a factor. Still, Sparty is #12 FBS on D, holding foes to 101 ypg less than their avg. QB Brian Lewerke isn't 100% & Rocky Lombardi has taken significant reps 2 of the L/3 wks. NU is ply'g their best down the stretch after st'g 0-6, having finished w/450+ yds in 7 str gms for the 1st time in sch! MSU is 3-9 as away chalk. NU is playing with a ton of confidence & will continue their upward trend. **FORECAST: NEBRASKA by 7**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY November 14TH:

Buffalo at OHIO - The Home tm has won 8 straight (7-1 ATS). LY they met in the regular ssn finale for both tms, 2 days after Ohio was eliminated from the MAC East race. Buffalo led 24-7 in 1Q, but Ohio tied it at 24 in the 3Q. After a PR to the Ohio 6, UB scored the GW td 2 plays later & held on, intercepting Ohio in the EZ w/1:20 left. LW UB destroyed Kent St 48-14 (-20), while Ohio (-4) was upset by Miami 30-28. If the Bulls win, they claim the MAC East crown, if Ohio wins they keep their Div hopes alive as they would need to beat Akron next week & have UB lose to 2-8 BG.

Miami at NORTHERN ILLINOIS - Winner will receive the Mallory Cup. NIU has won 7 straight reg ssn mtgs but Miami is 5-1 ATS the L/6. Last mtg was in '15 when NIU won 42-15 as a 15' pt AF. LW NIU clinched at least a share of the MAC West, beating Toledo 38-15 as a 3' pt HF and needs to win 1 of their L/2 to return to the MAC Championship gm. LW Miami upset Ohio 30-28 as a 4' pt HD. The RedHawks have score 30+ pt in 7 straight for the first time s/03, when they were led by QB Ben Roethlisberger but Toledo was avg 38.1 ppg into LW's gm & NIU held them to 15.

THURSDAY November 15TH:

Toledo by 24 over KENT ST - Last met in '15 when #24 UT won 38-7 as a 14 pt HF. UT is 10-2 SU va KSU s/88 but the HT is 5-1 SU s/94 incl 4 straight covers. LW Kent St was literally run over by Buffalo allowing 358 yds rushing & 6.3 ypg trailing 48-0 into 4Q in a 48-14 loss as a 20' pt AD. UT was run over by NIU allowing 296 yds rushing & 6.7 ypg but only trailed 10-9 before giving up blk'd punt td w/1:47 left 2Q & trailed 31-9 into 4Q in a 38-15 loss as a 3' pt AD. That loss ended their hopes of repeating as MAC Champs & they need to win 1 of their final 2 just to be bowl eligible.

HOUSTON by 11 over Tulane - It's Sr day in Houston. TU is 3-1 ATS as AAC rivals. UH is home for the 3rd time in 4 wks, while TU is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks & is on short rest. UH has faced the option, but all'd 344 (5.1) rush vs a Navy squad that is avg 296 rush ypg TY. TU's run gm was shutdown LW vs EC, so LSU transf QB Justin McMillan responded w/a car high 372 pass yds (3-0 ratio) in the win. UH enters having dropped B2B gms following their DD loss vs Temple LW as they were gashed for 312 (5.4) rush w/o DL Ed Oliver (CS). The loser of this gm will be eliminated from AAC Title gm contention.

NORTH TEXAS by 5 over Fau - NT is out for revenge after getting blown out twice LY by FAU incl 41-17 (+11) in the CUSA Title game. FAU totaled 728 (8.1) rush yds in those 2 mtgs. NT has been much stiffer against the run in '18, allowing just 104 (3.1) rush ypg. NT blew a 28-0 2Q lead vs ODU in last weeks 3 pt loss. The Mean Green's 395 yds was the lowest ttl that ODU has given up all year. FAU only led 10-9 at half vs WKU thanks to TO's and a missed fg, but finished +225 yds and rushed for 315 yds in the Owl's 19 pt win (-19). The Owls need 1 more win for bowl elig. FAU avg 74 ypg more than their foes allow (#18 in FBS). NT holds foes to 38 ypg below their avg (#38 in FBS).

FRIDAY November 16TH:

Memphis by 3 over SMU - It's Sr day in Dallas. UM is on a 4-0 SU/ATS series run, winning by an avg of 42 ppg & covering by an avg of 26' ppg! SMU is still 1 win away from bowl elig, but remains in control of their own destiny to reach the AAC Title gm following their 3rd win in 4 gms LW, while UM enters off perhaps their best gm of the ssn, holding Tulsa to a ssn low 252 yds. Against 4 common foes (Navy/Tulane/UConn/UCF) UM is 1-3 SU/2-2 ATS, but +6 ppg & +45 ypg, while SMU is 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS, but -3 ppg & -63 ypg! UM RB Darrell Henderson has ran for 1,446 (9.2) as he leads a rush attack avg 270 (6.5) ypg, while SMU all'd 365 (7.4) rush LW & is all'g 242 (4.8) in AAC play. We'll call for SMU to keep it closer than expected.

Boise St by 14 over NEW MEXICO - In 7 MW mtgs BSU is 6-1 SU/1-6 ATS. BSU is in a FSU/UTSt sandwich. Against 4 common foes (CSU/FSU/SDSt/AF) BSU is +23 ypg, while NM is -214 ypg! BSU is off a physical 24-17 win vs FSU, while NM lost their 5th str (42-24, outgained 623-305) vs AF. NM's DEF is giving up 481 ypg & their OFF is avg'g 79 ypg less than their foes allow. Boise's OFF (467 ypg) gains 83 more ypg than foes allow coming in, but we'll call for NM to keep it closer than expected as BSU has UTSt on deck.

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SATURDAY November 17TH:

MICHIGAN by 21 over Indiana - It's Sr day in Ann Arbor. UM has won 22 in a row SU in this series, but IU has covered the L/3. To say UM is ply'g at a high level is putting it mildly. They are #1 FBS on D, holding foes to 197 ypg below their avg & has won 5 str by 26 ppg. IU snapped a 4 gm losing skid LW & is now 1 win away from bowl elig, however they were out'f'd 27-18 & out'd 542-374 (+3 TO's). Against 4 common foes (MD/MSU/PSU/RU) UM is +26 ppg & +241 ypg, while IU is -3 ppg & +20 ypg. IU had a bye 2 wks ago & is travelling for just the 2nd time in 6 wks, while UM does have arch rival OSU on deck.

Pittsburgh by 10 over WAKE FOREST - 1st ever mtg. A win for Pitt clinches the ACC Coastal. Pitt beat an inj depleted VT team by 30 pts, racking up a sch! rec 654 yds in the process. The Panthers rushed for 492 yds with RB Ollison going for 235. WF needs 1 win for a bowl after pulling the outright upset at NCSt last week. The Deacons were 19' pt dogs and trailed 23-13 4Q when QB Newman, making his first car start, led 2 td drives for the win. The Deacons' held NCSt to a ssn low 47 (1.7) rush yds but they still allow 218 (5.5) rush ypg in ACC play and Pitt avg a ridiculous 310 (7.6) rush ypg in ACC play! Pitt is 14-7 ATS on the road under Narduzzi while WF is 0-3 as a HD TY and have suffered massive attrition at LB.

Iowa by 21 over ILLINOIS - It's Sr day in Champaign. These sch! have met each of the L4Y & IO is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS. Against 5 common foes (IOW/MN/MD/PSU/PU) IO is +4 ppg & +56 ypg, while IL is -23 ppg & -159 ypg. IO enters on a 3 gm losing skid following their emotional loss vs NW as they fumbled away each of their L/2 drives. After beating MN 2 wks ago by 24 pts, IL was brought back to reality in their 19 pt loss at NU LW as leading rusher Reggie Corbin was inj'd (CS). This gm will come down to the trenches as IL is avg 263 (6.3) rush ypg, while IO is all'g 96 (3.0) rush ypg. IO is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks, but is 15-2-1 as road chalk, while IL is 5-11 as a HD.

Virginia by 4 over GEORGIA TECH - The home team is 16-4 SU/15-3-1 ATS in the series. HC Mendenhall has a ton of experience against the option which he defended often as HC at BYU and LY UVA held GT to 220 (4.2) rush and pulled an outright upset as a 7' pt dog. UVA was likely looking ahead to this game last week, but still managed to cover in a 21 pt win over Liberty (only led 24-17 3Q). GT took advantage of 3 Miami TO's LW to get their 6th win, 27-21 (-2). The 'Hoos likely spent some extra time prepping for the option. UVA is only 3-6 as an AD vs ACC foes under Mendenhall but we can't help but like the 'Hoos in this matchup.

MINNESOTA by 3 over Northwestern - It's Sr Day in Minneapolis & MN is on a 6-3 ATS series run incl 3-1 at home. NW has won 5 of 6 & enters having clinched their 1st trip to the B10 Title gm after beating IO despite being short-handed in the secondary. MN fired their DC LW & then held PU to a ssn low 233 yds in their unexplainable 31 pt blowout win. MN is 1 win away from bowl elig. NW is on the 2nd of B2B away gms & enters off a physical 3 gm stretch vs UW, ND & Iowa. NW is 27-42 as chalk incl nearly losing outright at RU in their only other role as an AF, while MN is 9-4 as a HD. With NW having clinched the B10 West for the 1st time ever LW, MN has a huge situational edge.

Clemson by 25 over Duke - These 2 haven't met since 2010. Duke enters after beating rival NC 42-35 (-8). The Blue Devils put up over 600 yds for the 2nd time in 3 wks but that certainly won't happen vs Clem's D which held BC to 113 yds in the Tigers 27-7 win (-19). Clemson has held 6 foes to their ssn low yards. The Tigers avg 134 ypg more than their foes allow (#4 in FBS) and Duke's D is allowing 15 ypg more than their foes avg (#85 in FBS). Duke may be w/o AA LB Giles-Harris again and they've all'd 366 rush ypg their L/3. Duke covered their 2 most recent stints as 20+ pt dogs. Clemson is 3-9 as 20+ pt chalk in ACC play but covered their L/2.

Penn St by 28 over RUTGERS - It's Sr day in New Brunswick, but RU is just 1-5 ATS as the host in this series. PSU enters off a brutal 3 gm stretch vs IO, Mich & UW. They did hold UW to a ssn low 269 yds LW (4★ LPS Totals winner, totals now 14-4 L5W!). PSU relies on the run gm & while QB Trace McSorley is limited (knee inj) Miles Sanders picked up the slack LW w/159 (6.9). As expected RU was blown out by Mich LW, their 9th str loss overall. RU is all'g 235 (5.5) rush ypg in B10 play. PSU is 7-3 as road chalk & will pick up a blowout win.

Texas Tech by 10 over KANSAS ST - It's Sr day in the 'Little Apple'. KSU is on a 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS series run. TT enters losers of 3 str following their emotional loss vs TX, where they trailed by 17 4Q before tying the gm w/1:45 left & all'g the GW td w/2:21 remaining. QB Jett Duffey showed encouraging growth as a passer, throwing for a car high 444 (79%!, 4-1) as he continues to fill in for Alan Bowman. KSU enters off an emotional gm of their own, needing a 60/6pl td drive w/2:46 left to retain the Governor's Cup. TT is in a TX/BU sandwich, but needs 1 more win to become bowl elig, while KSU also still has bowl hopes. TT is 9-3 as road chalk. KSU is 12-4 as a HD. Could this be HOF HC Snyder's LHG?

EAST CAROLINA by 28 over Connecticut - It's Sr day in Greenville. The home team in this series was 3-0 ATS, covering by an avg of 25 ppg prior to LY's mtg, which was re-sked for a Sunday due to weather. UConn enters with just 1 win & while they finished w/ssn highs in pts (50), FD's (34) & ttl yds (580) LW vs SMU, they trailed by 3 td's at the half & gained 372 yds & 24 FD's in the 2H. EC enters having lost 5 str & their D, which had shown vast improvement from LY, has been torched the L2W. Against 3 common foes (USF/UCF/Mem) EC is -17 ppg & +34 ypg, while UConn is -29 ppg & -210 ypg! UConn is 12-23 as an AD.

TEMPLE by 17 over Usf - It's Sr day in Philly & this is TU's 1st home gm in nearly a month. The home team in this series has covered all 4 mtgs. TU enters having won 4 of 5 incl beating UH by DD's LW as RB Ryouell Armstead ran for 210 (7.0) & 6 td's! They still have a shot at reaching the AAC Title gm. Since st'g 7-0, USF has now lost 3 str by DD's after losing at Cincy. QB Blake Barnett was a surprise scratch (inj, CS). USF is on the 2nd of B2B away gms, is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks & is off a brutal 3 gm stretch vs UH, Tulane & Cincy with arch rival UCF on deck! TU is 9-4 as home chalk, but USF is 22-10 as an AD. USF is all'g 262 (5.3) rush ypg in AAC play.

GEORGIA by 35 over Massachusetts - First meeting. UGA enters off a 27-10 (-13) home win over Auburn. RB Swift had his third straight 100 yd effort, going for 186 (10.9) We had a 3★ Totals winner last week, taking the UNDER 58' in BYU vs UMass (Totals 3-0 LW, 7-1 L2W!!!) with the Cougars winning 31-13 (-14). In '16 & '17 UMass covered 3 gms vs SEC foes, twice vs Miss St & at Tenn, only losing those by 9 ppg despite being at least a 3 td dog in each. UGA is likely to put in extra time prepping for GT's option so we will call for UMass to keep it closer than expected.

Georgia Southern by 13 over COASTAL CAROLINA - LY CC ended their ssn w/ a 28-17 win vs GS (365-284 yg edge) so GS will be out for revenge. The Eagles are off B2B SBC losses (35-21 loss vs Troy LW) after starting 7-1. CC still needs 1 more win to reach a bowl after their 44-16 loss at home vs Ark St (outgained 454-293). These tms have 4 SBC common foes (Ark St, App St, ULM & Troy) and GS is 2-2, but gets outgained by 140 ypg & CC is 0-4 vs common foes and gets outgained by 176 ypg. CC does have issues stopping the run, all'g 251 rush ypg in SBC play & GS puts up 221 rush ypg in SBC play. GS is on a 9-4 ATS run and are tops in the FBS at forcing TO's (+21 on the ssn) and we like them to get back on track in this one.

Missouri by 3 over TENNESSEE - Mizzou has won & covered 4 of 6 SEC mtgs. The Tigers have put up 659 & 740 yds in their L/2 vs Tenn and they ran for over 420 yds in both. The Vols just pulled an upset as a HD last week vs KY, winning 24-7 (+5) while holding KY to 77 rush yds (2.2). Mizzou is bowl elig after squeaking by Vandy LW 33-28 (-15). The Vols are +61 yds at home and MO is -24 ypg on the road. Against 5 common foes (UGA, UF, SC, Bama, KY) MO is -5 ppg & -56 ypg while UT is -15 ppg & -83 ypg. MO has all'd just 12 sks TY but Tenn and LB Taylor had 4 sks vs KY. QB Locke has a 6-7 ratio in SEC play and you can't help but like the job HC Pruitt is doing so we lean with the dog.

Ohio St by 18 over MARYLAND - It's Sr day in College Park & this is MD's 3rd home gm in 4 wks. OSU is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS as B10 rivals & has won the L/2 by a comb'd score of 124-17! OSU held MSU to just 274 yds & 12 FD's in their near 3 td win LW, benefitting from a D td, a safety, & 2 scoring drives that began on Sparty's side of midfield. MD has dropped B2B Hms for the 1st time as TO's doomed them in their 2 pt loss at IU. They also lost RB Ty Johnson & QB Kasim Hill to inj's (CS). OSU is on the 2nd of B2B away gms & in an MSU/UM sandwich. MD is 1 win shy of bowl elig. MD is 7-14 as a DD dog, but OSU is 1-4 as road chalk.

NC State by 21 over LOUISVILLE - NCSU broke a 3 gm losing streak and we won a rare 3★ weekday LPS last year with the 'Pack beating Lville by 14 pts (+3). Lville's fired HC Petrino after their 54-23 (+20) loss at Syracuse. The Cards have lost their L/6 gms by 32.3 ppg and they get an angry Wolfpack team off their shocking loss to WF at home after leading by DD's in the 4Q. NCSU will need to get their run game going after putting up a ssn low 47 (1.7) LW vs one of the ACC's worst rush D. Luckily Lville allows 277 (6.0). NCSU avg 81 ypg more than their foes allow (#16 in FBS). UL allows 63 ypg more than their foes avg (#11 in FBS). NCSU is 8-3 as an AF UL is 1-8 ATS this year and on a 6-20 ATS run.

AUBURN by 38 over Liberty - 1st mtg. Liberty's 2nd straight vs a P5 foe and 3rd straight on the road. The Flames were only outgained 243-240 at half LW at UVA and trailed 31-24 3Q but lost 45-24 (+24). Auburn is off a 27-10 (+13) loss at UGA where they were outgained by 242 yds and allowed 303 (6.6) rush. Liberty catches a P5 foe in a huge sandwich for the 2nd straight week as Auburn has Bama on deck. The Flames avg 49 ypg more than their foes allow (#20 in FBS) but they've faced a much weaker sked (#49 vs #120) and QB Calvert had a 16-7 ratio in his F/8 but 2-7 ratio in his L/2. The situation favors Liberty and Aub is 5-18-1 as a HF but the Tigers will want to get some confidence before the Iron Bowl and won't be afraid to lay a smackdown.

CHARLOTTE by 1 over FIU - Charlotte is 0-2 SU but 2-0 ATS with both losses coming by 1 point vs FIU. The Panthers enter off a 45-7 (-10). FIU held a 453-245 yd edge and were +4 TO's. Charlotte must win out to get bowl elig after LW's 30-13 (+14) loss at Marshall. The game was tied 13-13 mid 3Q but UC was held to a ssn low 185 yds. UC holds foes to 97 ypg below their avg (#15 in FBS) while FIU allows 5 ypg more than their foes avg (#77 in FBS). The Panthers do have the edge on OFF and QB Morgan has a 16-1 ratio in his L/6 but UC has the edge on Def. UC is 6-2 as a HD so we will call for the 49ers to pull an outright upset on Senior Day.

BYU by 18 over New Mexico St - BYU won both previous mtgs, 42-7 as a 22' pt HF in '11 & 50-14 as a 27 pt AF in '12. NMSt is off a bye while BYU is off a long trip to the East coast where they defeated another fellow independent, UMass 35-16 as a 14 pt AF. The Aggies after winning a bowl LY in their final ssn in the SBC, have struggled as a Indep TY with just 3 wins & are just 2-8 ATS including 1-6 as a dog. BYU is 3-0 as a DD Fav TY & with Utah on deck needs to win here to become bowl eligible but they have opened as a 23 pt HF & that is a bit high for our taste. The Aggies offense struggled early in the ssn, but have scored an avg 38 ppg their L/5 & should be able to keep it inside the number here as the Cougars have scored over 35 pts just once TY.

WYOMING by 6 over Air Force - AF holds a 28-25-3 SU lead in the Front Range rivalry. WY is 5-2 SU, and is on a 9-0 ATS run vs AF. LY WY won 28-14 despite being outgained 378-229 (+2 TO's). WY is off their 2nd bye off the ssn & had extra time to prep for the option. AF is off a 42-24 win at NM (623-305 yd edge), but this is their 4th road gm in 6 weeks. WY's OFF has put up 441 ypg (358 rush ypg) since making QB Chambers the starter. The Cowboy rush attack will face a AF DEF that has all'd 116 rush ypg the L/4 MW gms. WY holds MW foes to 108 yds below their avg & only allow 109 rush ypg in MW play. WY is 5-1 as a HF.

Utah by 3 over COLORADO - Following a 7 pt home win in the 1st gm with QB Shelley (18-31-262, 2 rush TD) in the starting lineup for the inj'd Huntley, the Utes head to Boulder to take on a CU squad that they've knocked off in 5 of their 7 P12 matchups (just 2-5 ATS). CU remains a win away from bowl eligibility after LW's 24 pt home loss to Wash St where they were outFD'd (26-12) & outgained (477-297) by significant clips. In LY's meeting in SLC, the Utes handed the Buffs a 21 pt defeat (-10) despite not having the services of Huntley in that one as well.

Utah St by 28 over COLORADO ST - CSU has won 3 of the L/4 SU incl LY. Utah St just beat up SJSt 62-24 (804-400) for their 9th straight win. Utah St's OFF avg's 565 ypg vs MW foes & gains 149 ypg more than MW foes allow. CSU is off a 49-10 loss at Nev (636-260). The Rams pass attack is their lone strength (330 pass ypg, 62% in MW play) but the Aggies pass

D ranks #21 & allows opposing MW QB's to hit just 47%. These teams faced 4 common MW foes & Utah St is 4-0 (avg score 51-19) while CSU is 2-2 (avg score 29-31). CSU is 4-9 ATS vs MW foes the L/2Y, while Utah St is 6-1-1 as a DD MW favorite the L/3Y. Utah St has Boise on deck (winner goes to MW title game), but are winning MW games by an avg of 28 ppg.

Notre Dame by 7 over SYRACUSE - This game is being played in Yankee Stadium. These two last met in '16 with Cuse losing 50-33 (+10). Cuse enters after beating up on hapless Louisville 54-23 (-20). The Orange ran for a ssn high 326 (5.9) but will have a tough time getting a repeat performance against an Irish D that allows 143 (3.7) rush. ND smoked FSU at home by 29 pts last week and finished +173 ypg despite not having QB Book. Earlier this year Cuse beat that same FSU team by 30 pts and was +201 yds. Cuse avg 58 ypg more than their foes allow (#29 in FBS) but ND holds their foes to 75 ypg below their avg (#27 in FBS). Cuse has covered 9 of their L/11 as a dog while ND is 1-6-1 when favored by 7+ pts.

APPALACHIAN ST by 28 over Georgia St - App St is 4-0 SU & 3-1 ATS vs GSt. In their 4 mtgs App St has outscored GSt 129-16 (avg MOV 28 pts). LY App St led just 10-7 at HT, but got 3 2H TD's to win 31-10 (430-292). App St dominated TXSt LW (38-7, 468-218) & have held all but 3 foes to 9 pts or less. App St DEF is holding SBC foes to 112 ypg below their avg. GSt is on a 5 gm SBC losing streak (lost LW to LA 36-22) & allows SBC foes to gain 473 ypg & 62 ypg more than they avg coming in. App St lost star RB Moore (inj), but bkp Darrynton Evans (733 yds, 6.5 ypc, 6 TD) is not much of a step back & GSt allows 251 ypg rush. QB Thomas is back for App St & they are on a 11-2 ATS run, while GSt is just 3-9-3 ATS dating back to last ssn.

MARSHALL by 30 over Uta - Marshall is out for revenge after losing LY w/o giving up a td, 9-7 (+2). The Herd are still alive in the CUSA East but need to win out. Last week they held Charlotte to a ssn low 185 yds in their 30-13 (-14) win. With their RB's inj depleted, RB Knox got his first carries of the year and went for 116 yds against a UC Def that had all'd just 82 (2.9) rush entering the gm. Now they face the FBS' worst OFF in UTSA who avg 146 ypg less than their foes allow. UTSA enters after getting beat by a comb'd 97-10 the L/2 wks. The RoadRunners are -188 ypg in CUSA play while Marshall is +47 ypg. UTSA is on a 3-15 ATS run. Our Power Plays Newsletter calls for UTSA to get just 134 yds so we don't mind laying the points.

Stanford by 1 over CALIFORNIA - This will mark the 121st "Big Game" with Stanford & Cal meeting every year s/1946. Following 4 losses in a 5-gm span heading into LW's matchup against OSU on "The Farm," the Cardinal earned bowl eligibility much later than anybody though with a 31 pt win against OSU (ssn-best 48 pts & 596 yds). Cal meanwhile earned yet another upset LW at USC (15 unanswered pts in 2H, 1st win S/2003) to earn bowl eligibility of their own. While the Cardinal have won 8 straight (6-2 ATS) in this series by 20 ppg, LY's meeting saw them claim just a 3 pt home win as 14 pt chalk. With Cal continuing to play opponents tough (all'g just 319 ypg on the yr), we'll give the visitor only the slightest of edges in this one.

OREGON by 3 over Arizona St - Following a 3 pt victory over the Bruins LW in their FHG of the ssn, the Sun Devils head to Eugene having clinched bowl eligibility for the 7th time in the L/8Y. While the Ducks earned their 6th win a few wks back against the Bruins, they were unable to get the job done LW against a banged-up Utes squad (UO outgained 494-405 in the 7 pt loss). In LY's early ssn trip to Tempe, a 2 TD dog Sun Devils team delivered the outright upset (489-401 yd edge). While it's hard to fathom another outright victory here for ASU, their solid play in the 2H of the year has us calling for a tight matchup in Autzen.

WASHINGTON ST by 6 over Arizona - The Wildcats return from their bye week after a pair of solid home wins against Oregon & Colorado and needing 1 more victory to become bowl eligible (ASU on deck). The Cougs meanwhile have rattled off 6 straight wins (incl a 24 pt victory LW in Boulder to stay within range of the College Playoff. With the pressure of delivering on a weekly basis in the Palouse and the Wildcats covering 3 in a row coming in, we'll lean with the AD here.

Nevada by 13 over SAN JOSE ST - NEV is 13-2 SU (11-4 ATS) vs SJSt s/2002. LY NEV's Dameon Baber had 3 return TD's (tied NCAA record) & the Pack beat SJSt 59-14 (441-302). LTH in '16 SJSt won on a GW TD run w/ 50 sec left. Nev's DEF is improved from LY (all'd 472 ypg vs MW foes) as they allow 352 ypg in MW play & hold those foes to 70 yds below their ssn avg. SJSt's OL struggles to open running lanes (65 ypg rush) and protecting the QB (34 sks all'd) & NEV has 29 sks this ssn. NEV beat UH (40-22) & CSU (49-10) this ssn, but SJSt lost (44-41 5 OT) to UH & CSU (42-30).

BAYLOR by 7 over TCU - It's Sr day in Waco, but TCU is on a 5-1 ATS run in this series. BU enters having lost 3 of 4, while TCU has lost 4 of 5, but each are still p'g for bowl elig. BU failed to score on 5 of their 7 RZ appearances at ISU LW that featured an ugly brawl along with QB Charlie Brewer being ejected 2H (may half to miss 1H here). Inj's are catching up to TCU as they were held to ssn lows in ttl (222) & rush (-7) yds in their blowout loss at WV. TCU is on the 2nd of B2B away gms & is travelling a 3rd time in 4 wks, while BU is home for just the 2nd time in the L/6 wks. BU is 30-18 as home chalk & will become bowl elig here, a huge improvement after just 1 win LY.

NAVY by 2 over Tulsa - It's Sr day in Annapolis & this is Navy's lone home gm in a 6 wk stretch, while TU is on the 2nd of B2B away gms. As AAC rivals Navy is 3-0 SU/ATS, winning by an avg of 12 ppg & covering by an avg of 5 ppg. These tms are nearly a mirror of each other in terms of strengths & weaknesses. Against 3 common foes (Mem/Tem/UH) Navy is 1-2 SU/1-1 ATS, -6 ppg & -48 ypg, while TU is 0-3 SU/1-2 ATS, -18 ppg & -65 ypg. TU is 14-7 as an AD. In AAC play TU is -5 ppg & -54 ypg, while Navy is -12 ppg & -98 ypg. We'll back a TU squad that has shown more life & has a SU win over a solid Memphis team.

TEXAS A&M by 21 over Uab - The Aggies are 11-0 vs current CUSA teams but have covered just 1 of their L/5 vs those teams. UAB clinched a berth in the CUSA Title game by rallying to beat SM last week 26-23 (-12) in OT. The Blazers were again w/o QB Erdely but did hold a 304-165 yd edge. We picked up a 3★ Key Selection winner on these pages LW as A&M beat Ole Miss 38-24 (-13). RB Williams rushed for 228 (7.4) and leads the SEC with 1159 (5.9). UAB was held to 180 yds LY in their most recent trip to an SEC foe. A&M holds opponents to 78 (3.0) rush ypd and they've faced a much tougher sked (#11 vs #127). The Aggies do have LSU on deck and UAB is 8-3 as a dog but UAB's OFF is dependant on their ability to run and A&M shuts the run down.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 14 over Arkansas - The home tm is 1-4 SU/ATS in the series and Ark has cov'd 3 of the L/4. The Bulldogs are off their expected beatdown from Bama, losing 24-0 but can take some solice in the fact they held Bama to a ssn low 305 yds (261 below their avg). Ark fell behind LSU 24-3 last week but scored 2 4Q td's to get within a td. The Hogs were outgained 359-216. Ark avg 36 ypg less than their foes allow (#101 in FBS) while MSU holds foes to 134 ypg below their avg (#4 in FBS) and they've held their L/3 foes to a ssn low. Against 4 common foes (Bama, Aub, A&M, LSU) MSU is -2.2 ppg & +22 ypg while Ark is -19.7 ppg & -110 ypg. Ark is ply'g their first true home gm s/Sept 22. MSU has failed to cover their L/3 on Sr Day.

SOUTHERN MISS by 1 over Louisiana Tech - SM has pulled 3 straight outright upsets in this series incl LTH on Senior Day as a 14' pt dog, winning by 15 pts. SM enters after nearly upsetting UAB on the road. The Golden Eagles led 13-7 at half despite missing QB Abraham (inj, CS) but were held to 31 yds the rest of the way, losing 26-23 (+12) in OT. LT only led Rice 21-13 4Q before adding a td with 5:52 left. The Bulldogs avg 23 ypg less than their foes allow (#91 in FBS). SM allows 82 ypg less than foes avg (#22 in FBS) and held both UAB and Marshall to their ssn low yards. Against 4 common foes (Rice, NT, UTSA, UAB) LT is +6 ppg & +5 ypg while SM is -0.5 ppg & +97 ypg. SM is 9-1 ATS on Senior day and 4-0 as a HD, so we will call for the upset.

AKRON by 14 over Bowling Green - Prior to LY's 34-23 win as 2' pt AF, the Zips had lost 8 in a row SU/ATS. The Falcons are off their first win over an FBS foe TY as they beat now 1-10, CM 24-13 as a 7 pt AD. They actually trailed 13-0 at HT but scored 17 unanswered in the 3Q & sealed the win with a FR td w/6:54 left. Akron QB Nelson was inj'd vs 2 wks ago vs NIU & after being expected to play LW, missed the EM gm & is status is unknown at press time (CS). In his first career start LW, UA's rF QB Ramart hit just 4-15-29 with 3 int's. If called upon again this wk, he will at least be in the friendly confines of InfoCision Stadium and after facing EM, with our #57 def will now face BG's #125 def. IF Nelson returns we like this even more.

LSU by 38 over Rice - These two haven't met since 1995. Rice is playing their 4th road game in 5 weeks and they've lost 20 straight vs FBS foes after dropping last week's game at LT 28-13 (+24). LSU is in an SEC sandwich off a misleading 24-17 (-13) win over Ark where they led 24-3 4Q and held Ark to 61 yds in the 1H. Rice does have an SEC transfer QB in Shawn Stankavage (Vandy) but he's only compl'd 57% w/a 9-7 ratio and hasn't faced anything close to the LSU defense. LSU is 0-5 ATS under Orgeron when favored by 20+ pts and Rice has covered 4 of their L/5 as a 20+ pt dog.

VANDERBILT by 6 over Mississippi - UM is 4-1 SU in the series and the home team is only 3-7 ATS. Ole Miss led A&M last week 21-14 3Q but couldn't contain RB Williams who went for 228 yds. QB Shurmur threw for 249 yds and 3 td's while RB Vaughn went for 182 (12.1) as Vandy nearly upset Mizzou last week, losing 33-28 (+15). Vandy led 21-13 at half and didn't trail until 4Q. The Dores must win their L/2 to get to a bowl. Both tms struggle defensively. RB Vaughn has made a huge difference for Vandy (667, 6.8) and Ole Miss allows 245 (5.4) in SEC play. UM is on a 1-7 ATS run and Vandy will be excited playing their first home gm in 5 weeks.

Boston College by 13 over FLORIDA ST - BC is fav'd at FSU for the first time as ACC foes. BC ended 7 game losing streak to FSU LY on their Red Bandana day with a 35-3 (+5). FSU is off 3 straight losses by 32.3 ppg. The Noles must win their L/2 games to keep their 36 year bowl streak alive. Luckily for FSU they get a BC team that is beat up from a physical loss to Clemson, 27-7 (+19). QB Brown was inj'd in the first series (CS) and BC managed a ssn low 113 yds (only td was a PR). The 'Noles went back to QB Francois in their loss to ND and he completed just 49% in their 42-13 (+16') loss. FSU holds foes to 43 ypg below their avg (#39 in FBS) and BC avg 14 ypg less than their foes allow (#87 in FBS). We will call for BC to win by just under 2 td's.

OKLAHOMA by 45 over Kansas - It's Sr day in Norman & OU is home for the 3rd time in 4 wks. OU is in an OSU/WV sandwich, while KU is on the 2nd of B2B away gms. Both enter off emotionally draining rivalry gms as OU won a back-and-forth shootout in Bedlam, while KU all'd the GW td w/2:46 left & QB Peyton Bender fumbled from the KSU 32 w/20 left. OU is on a 4-0 SU/ATS series run, winning by an avg of 46 ppg & covering by an avg of 10 ppg. KU is 22-37-2 as an AD, while OU is 47-28 as home chalk.

WASHINGTON by 28 over Oregon St - Following a 2nd consec DD loss LW on the road against Stanford where they gave up over 500 yds for the 7th time in 9 matchups, the Beavers head North to take on a Huskies squad who's won 6 straight in the series (5-1 ATS) by an avg of 29 ppg. UW returns from their bye week having dropped 5 consec covers including just a 4 pt home win as DD chalk vs Stanford. The Huskies have proven they can win big before their Apple Cup rivalry & OSU has lost P12 gms TY by 28, 42 & 31 pts & we'll call for another Beaver blowout loss.

ARKANSAS ST by 17 over Ulm - Ark St has dominated this series (8-0 SU & ATS) winning by 27 ppg.

REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK..... GEORGIA SOUTHERN SERIES PLAY OF THE WEEK..... ARKANSAS ST SITUATION PLAY OF THE WEEK..... MINNESOTA

LY Ark St won 67-50 (781-571) & Hansen threw for a schl rec 590 yds. Hansen (65.5%, 22-6 ratio) leads an OFF that in their L/4 games has avg 493 ypg & 44 ppg. ULM's pass D ranks #129. Ark St is 7-2 as an SBC HF & ULM is just 6-11 ATS overall & has the #6 SBC D (430 ypg, 32 ppg), but has held their L/3 foes to 225 ypg & 16 ppg. ULM's D does have 29 sks incl 17 sks their L/4 gms. Against 4 common foes (GS, SA, GST, CC) Ark St & ULM are both 3-1 (Ark St lost to GS 28-21, ULM lost to GST 46-14) & the Red Wolves are +151 ypg, while ULM is +120 ypg. Given the series history, we like Ark St to get their 9th straight win.

TROY by 21 over Texas St - 4th mtg as SBC foes, 3rd mtg here. Troy is 3-0 SU & ATS & the avg MOV is 33 pts. LY in their home finale Troy led 41-0 HT (470-106) & won 62-9 (641-300). Troy is 19-3 SU (13-8-1 ATS) the L3Y in SBC play, while TXSt has lost 2 SU wins the L3Y in the SBC, but are 10-12 ATS. TXSt struggles vs the run in SBC play (213 ypg all'd) & Troy's strength is their run game (210 ypg in SBC play). TXSt's OFF (#8 SBC) gains 132 less ypg than their foes allow & face Troy's DEF that is #2 in the SBC. Troy also leads the SBC in sks (34) & will face a TXST OL that allows the 2nd most sks in the SBC (25). Troy is 5-0 vs SBC common foes & outgains them by 89 ypg while TXSt is 1-4 & gets outgained by 36 ypg (1 win vs GST). Troy is off a 35-21 win vs GS (454-291) & has a big gm next week vs App St to decide the SBC East.

LOUISIANA by 20 over South Alabama - LA is 4-2 (LA won L2Y SU & ATS) and the home team is 5-1 SU/ATS. LA's OFF got back on track LW w/a 36-22 win vs GST (525-373) & at home avg 554 ypg & 45 ppg. LA also faces a SA D all'g 459 ypg, incl 66 ypg more than foes allow. LA needs their OFF to play well b/c their D is #9 SBC, all'g 449 ypg & 34 ppg. Jags QB Orth (65%, 10-6 ratio) isn't 100% & not having him would hurt this already mediocre OFF (326 ypg, 22 ppg). LA is 6-2-2 ATS, while SA is 2-6 as an AD in SBC play. LA is motivated to get to a bowl under new HC Napier & a win here would do it. We like the Cajuns to win big.

Miami FI by 7 over VIRGINIA TECH - This is a match up of two teams in the midst of disappointing seasons and surprisingly, still not bowl eligible. UM needs 1 more win to become bowl elig. The 'Canes had 3 TO's vs GT and lost despite holding the Jacets to their 2nd lowest yards tll of the ssn w/163. VT was crushed at Pitt, giving up 492 (13.7) rush yds and letting Pitt put up a school rec 654 yds. Blacksburg hasn't been the tough place to play that you'd expect as VT has lost 3 straight at home this year and they are on an 0-5 ATS run. DC Foster's unit allows 60 ypg more than their opp's avg which should help a struggling Miami OFF that avg 15 ypg less than their opp's allow. Neither team inspires much confidence but the 'Canes have a huge defensive edge.

WKU by 7 over Utep - This weeks pillow fight features two teams comb'g for 2 FBS wins this year. In WKU's first 6 losses, 4 of them came by a fg, but since then they've dropped 3 straight by 21, 19 & 19. We went against UTEP last week as a 3★ LPS, and picked up a winner against the Miners who were off their first win in 20 games and playing CUSA East leader MT. UTEP fell behind 48-18 before scoring 2 td's to make the final score misleading. We can't possibly suggest making a play on either of these bad teams so we will call for it to finish right at the line.

TEXAS by 2 over Iowa St - It's Sr day in Austin & the home team is on a 4-2 SU/ATS series run. This gm has HUGE B12 Title gm implications as the loser will be eliminated. We upgraded TX from a 3★ on these pages LW to a 4★ LPS (Sat ★ rated plays finished 9-3!) in their win at TT as they were in clear control, up by 17 4Q, before needing a GW 75/71 td drive w/21 left. ISU led by 3 td's 4Q LW in their costly win vs BU that saw star RB David Montgomery ejected for fighting, which may result in him being susp TW (CS). In B12 play TX is +5 ppg, but -20 ypg, while ISU is +8 ppg & +28 ypg. TX is 2-9 as home chalk. ISU is 8-3 as an AD.

FRESNO ST by 20 over San Diego St - FSU is 5-1 ATS in the series. FSU is off a loss at BSU, where they led 17-3 HT, but were held scoreless in the 2H & lost 24-17. SDSt did beat BSU earlier TY on the road. SDSt is off a 27-24 loss to UNLV (outgained 436-368) & were held to 89 rush yds. With a win here FSU clinches a berth in the MW Title gm. Their D is holding MW foes to 325 ypg & 85 yds below their ssn avg, while FSU's OFF avg 498 ypg & 51 ppg at home. They face a tough SDSt D that allows just 279 ypg vs MW foes. FSU held NV & UNLV to 3 pts each & SDSt's 2 MW losses are to NV & UNLV. FSU is 18-4-2 ATS, while SDSt is just 2-8 ATS.

HAWAII by 1 over Unlv - "Ninth Island showdown." UNLV is 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS incl LY when UNLV scored 21 3Q pts to pull ahead & then hung on for a 31-23 win. UH started the ssn 6-1 SU (467 ypg & 38 ppg F/7 gms) but have lost the L/4 (362 ypg, 21 ppg). UNLV snapped their 6 gm skid w/ a 27-24 win at SDSt, but there are concerns facing a pass-happy UH team. UH avg's 308 pass ypg & WR Ursua is the #4 WR in FBS (1161 yds, 15 TD). UNLV allows QB to hit on 69% in MW play & has the #115 pass DEF. UNLV QB Rogers could be back & UH lost leading tk'r Tavai for ssn. UH is just 4-16-1 ATS & is just 2-12 ATS as a HF the L3Y, so we'll side w/ the Rebels to keep it close.

TUESDAY Nov 20

Northern Illinois at WESTERN MICHIGAN - The HT has won 4 of the L/5 but is just 1-5 ATS the L/6. LY WM had 3 td's off 3 NIU TO's, but couldn't hold onto 28-21 & 31-28 4Q leads. as NIU scored the GW td with 6:20 left. If NIU lost LW & WM won, then this is for the MAC West Championship, if both didn't happen, then NIU has the MAC Championship game on deck & WM will be looking to improve their bowl chances.

Ball ST at MIAMI - After playing just 9x s/2000, the MAC has granted this matchup, "rivalry status", so they will now play every ssn. LY in the regular ssn finale, Miami led 14-0 after 1Q & 28-0 at HT in a 28-7 win as a 18 pt AF. If Miami upset NIU LW, the RedHawks need a win here to become bowl eligible, if not, then both teams are playing for pride & the Red Bird Rivalry Trophy. 4★ NEW ORLEANS over Philadelphia - The Eagles fell to 4-5 on the ssn following their SNF loss to the Cowboys where they all'd 400+ yds for just the 3rd time TY. The Saints meanwhile are the hottest team in the NFL following their 8th straight win (7th consec cover) LW in CIN (4★ Newsletter Winner!) where they finished with a 509-284 yd edge. In their most recent meeting back in '15, the hometown Eagles had no issue disposing of the Saints in the easy 39-17 victory (34-19 FD & 519-388 yd edges). Despite covering 4 of their past 5 as an AD heading in, there's no way that we go against this red-hot Saints team at the moment inside of the Superdome.

FORECAST: NEW ORLEANS by 14

3★ Tampa Bay over NY GIANTS - Following a MNF trip to the Bay Area a wk ago, the Giants return to NY sitting at just 1-7 as of presstime. The Bucs meanwhile are on the road for the only time in a 5-week span following their 6th loss in the L/7 gms LW against WAS where their offense (avg 29 ppg coming in) was held to just 3 pts (had 501 yds but 4 TO's). In LY's matchup in TB, the Bucs connected on a GW 34-yd FG as time expired (434-379 yd edge). While the Bucs do head into this contest having covered just 1 of their L/7, LW's inability to put points on the board despite the large yardage total gives us value against the Giants who have dropped all 4 home matchups so far in '18 (SU & ATS) by 12 ppg!

FORECAST: TAMPA BAY by 8

2★ Houston over WASHINGTON - Only HG in a 4-wk span for a WAS squad who's patchwork OL and fortunate defense (held TB to just 3 pts & forced 4 TO's, allowed 501 tl yds!) saw them get a big road victory to stay atop the NFC East standings. HOU meanwhile returns from their wk off (6-1 ATS after a bye) having won 6 straight (4-2 ATS) incl a Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner over DEN 2 wks ago! With a terrible performance in their most recent home gm against ATL (24 pt loss, ATL 491-366 yd edge) and the fact that they were held to just 286 yds in LW's victory, leaning in the Redskins' direction is unwise at the moment.

OTHER PLAYS

Green Bay at SEATTLE - Thursday - The '18 schedule onslaught continues for the Seahawks who take on the Packers following matchups against the Chargers and Rams (3★ LP & 2★ Newsletter Winner!). Things haven't been much easier for GB however as they're on the road for the 3rd time in 4 wks (at MIN on deck) following a 19 pt win in Lambeau against the Dolphins where we cashed our 10th straight Top Play LP Winner to start the year (377-294 yd edge). In their ssn opening meeting a year ago in GB, the Packers (-3) held the Seahawks to just 12 FD's & 225 yds in the 17-9 victory. While SEA has lost 3 straight in this series, keep in mind that the home team is on a perfect 6-0 SU/ATS run in regular season contests. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Carolina by 6 over DETROIT - After rattling off 5 straight covers earlier in the ssn including a SU home upset over the Patriots, the bottom has fallen out for the Lions over the past 3 wks with consec losses SU & ATS including LW on the road against the Bears where they trailed by 24 pts going into the 4Q (CHI 402-305 yd edge). The Panthers had also been on a roll entering LW's trip to PIT with a 3-0 SU/ATS mark (11 ppg). Unfortunately, that run was disrupted LW against a Steelers team that put up 52 pts (tied for most all'd in franchise history) en route to an easy 31 pt victory. In LY's trip to DET, the Panthers (+2) jumped out to a 27-10 lead in the 4Q before the Lions made it interesting late with a pair of TD's in the final 6 minutes (CAR 362-242 yd edge). With DET having their Thanksgiving home contest on deck against the Bears (2nd matchup in 11 days) and having gone just 4-11-1 ATS as a HD, we'll back the Panthers (5-1 SU/ATS off a SU loss) to earn another win in "Motown" this week.

ATLANTA by 8 over Dallas - The Falcons return to ATL for their only HG in a 4-wk span following a surprising 28-16 loss in CLE where they fell back to 4-5 on the ssn. The Cowboys meanwhile earned their 1st road win of the '18 campaign LW in PHI behind 187 tl yds & 2 TD's from RB Elliott. In DAL's mid year trip to ATL a season ago, the Falcons went on a 17-0 run in the 2H to claim the easy 20 pt victory (336-233 yd edge). With both the Cowboys (off a SU win as a 7 pt dog) and Falcons (off a SU loss as a 5' pt favorite) having unexpected results LW, we get some added line value here with the home team who desperately needs a win to stay alive in the NFC.

BALTIMORE by 6 over Cincinnati - Following a rough home effort LW against the Saints (4★ Newsletter Winner, Saints 509-284 yd edge) in their return from bye, the Bengals head to BAL in search of the ssn sweep after a 34-23 victory back in Wk 2 (led 21-0 in 2Q). While the Ravens did go into their own bye week on a 3-gm losing skid, the losses came to some of the NFL's elite in NO, CAR & PIT. With CIN's top weapon WR Green (3 TD in 1st matchup) expected to be out again here with an injury and the Ravens' 8-2 ATS mark after a week off, we'll call for them to get back on track here with rookie QB Jackson likely making his 1st career start for the inj'd Flacco while adding on to their solid 13-6 ATS run against the AFC North in the process.

Tennessee by 3 over INDIANAPOLIS - Following yet another outright upset victory (5th of the ssn) LW in Nashville where they held the Patriots to just 284 tl yds, the Titans head to the AFC South road for the next 2 weeks (MNF at HOU on deck). The Colts meanwhile jumped out to a 29-16 HT lead and held on late in the 3 pt victory over the Jags. The Titans' 2 wins over the Colts a season ago were not only key to their WC playoff berth, but were also their 1st wins in the series in 6 yrs! With an outstanding 7-1 ATS run as a dog coming in, we'll go ahead and call for the Titans to earn yet another one here against a Colts squad that's on just a 6-12-2 ATS mark inside of their division.

LA CHARGERS by 10 over Denver - After an easy 14 pt win LW in the "Black Hole" against the Raiders where they held the Raiders to just 6 pts, the Chargers return home having won 6 consec gms to stay within reach of the Chiefs in the AFC West. While the Broncos were on a perfect 6-0 ATS run following their bye week from 2010-2015, the past 2 ssn's have seen them drop the past two by 8 ppg (both as chalk). They head to LA on just a 3-12-1 ATS run against DIV foes that includes a miserable 21-0 loss here a year ago. With the Chargers having covered 4 of their past 5 heading in along with DEN failing to cover 16 of their L/21 overall, the smart money is on the home team in this one.

ARIZONA by 7 over Oakland - Following their only HG in a 4-week span LW against the Chargers where they were held without a TD for the 3rd time in 4 contests (14 pt loss LW to LAC), the Raiders head to the desert to take on a Cardinals squad whose only wins in '18 came against OAK's Bay Area rival SF in Wk's 5 & 8. LW's trip to Arrowhead saw the Cardinals held to just 260 yds in the 26-14 defeat. While the Cardinals have lost their first 2 matchups against AFC foes by a combined 47 points, backing a disinterested Raiders team that's on a 2-11-2 overall ATS run against the NFC isn't in the cards for this weekend.
