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## KEY SELECTION

### BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - AT&T STADIUM - ARLINGTON, TX

**3★ Texas (+) over Oklahoma** - This is Oklahoma's tenth B12 Title game appearance (8-1 SU/6-2-1 ATS) and Texas' sixth (3-2 SU/2-3 ATS) as these schools are meeting in the Title game for the first time. In their prior meeting this year on October 6th Texas led by 21 points in the fourth quarter, but Oklahoma scored three td's in a six minute span to tie it with 2:38 left. The 'Horns then drove 52/9pl and hit the game winning 40 yard fg with :09 left to give us an **outright winner for the "Underdog Play of the Week" on these pages.** Texas did allow a season high 7.2 yards per carry. The last five meetings have been decided by seven points or less and Texas is on a 6-0 ATS series run. In B12 play Oklahoma is 8-1 SU/4-5 ATS, +14 ppg and +135 ypg, while Texas is 7-2 SU/4-5 ATS, +6 ppg and +7 ypg. Oklahoma Heisman hopeful QB Kyler Murray has thrown for 3,674 (71%, 37-7) while adding 853 (7.5) on the ground to lead the #1 offense that averages 202 ypg more than their foes allow. Texas will have the edge on defense, while the Sooners have a slight special teams advantage. 'Horns QB Sam Ehlinger played through a shoulder injury in last weeks win at Kansas, but his B12 record of 308 consecutive passes without an interception came to an end. Meanwhile, we won a **3★ LPS Total on the OVER** in Oklahoma's 59-56 shootout win at WV last week. Texas head coach Tom Herman continues to thrive in the underdog role as he's now 13-1 ATS with 10 outright upsets and we'll call for the 'Horns to keep this game closer than expected. **FORECAST: Oklahoma by 3**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

### CUSA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - JOHNNY "RED" FLOYD STADIUM - MURFREESBORO, TN

**2★ Uab over MIDDLE TENNESSEE** - This is a rematch from LW when MT shut UAB down, holding them to 89 tl yards and -1 rush yds. As a result, MT gets to host their first ever Conf Title gm. The Blue Raiders started the ssn just 3-3 and appeared to lose QB Stockstill to inj in their 24-21 (+2) loss at FIU. Stockstill surprisingly returned the following week, and led MT to wins in their next 5 CUSA games and only losing to KY 34-23 (+16). Stockstill has a 16-3 ratio in his L/6 and his top WR, Ty Lee, has 2 100-yd efforts in his L/3. UAB has lost B2B games after winning 9 of their F/10. The big concern has to be their run game. In the F/10 gms, UAB avg 253.3 rush ypg (5.4). Their OL is dealing with inj's having lost their top 2 C's to inj. They lost LG Cook to illness just before the game vs MT and RG Powers was ejected in the 2Q, leaving the Blazers with just 2 starting OL. It's possible the entire OL could be back for this game. RB Brown has 993 (4.6) but only had 1 carry last week after feeling discomfort in pregame. QB Erdely, who missed 3 str starts, returned last week but went just 9-20-90-0-1. MT holds foes to 33 ypg below their avg (#42 in FBS). LB DQ Thomas had 2 sks vs UAB, bringing his ttl to 8 on the ssn (6.5 tfl) and S Bush is #2 in CUSA w/5 int. UAB's defense is holding foes to 77 ypg below their average (#20 in FBS). The Blazers allow just 72 (2.2) rush ypg in CUSA play and they are tied for #1 in CUSA w/37 sks. MT has covered 7 of their L/8 as HF but UAB is 8-4 as a dog and if they get their OL and RB Brown healthy, can win this game. **FORECAST: Uab by 3**

## Friday November 30th

### PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LEVI'S STADIUM - SANTA CLARA, CA

**2★ Washington over Utah** - Following a come-from-behind 8 pt win a week ago against rival BYU in the "Holy War" where they stormed back from a 27-7 deficit late in the 3Q, the Utes head to their 1st P12 Championship in its 8th year of existence sitting at 9-3 SU on the year (7-4-1 ATS). The Huskies meanwhile earned their 2nd berth in the P12 Title Game after taking advantage of blizzard conditions in LW's "Apple Cup" against the pass-happy Cougars (487-237 yd edge). Their 1st trip to Santa Clara in '16 went heavily in their favor with the Huskies claiming a 41-10 victory (-7) over Colorado (22-9 FD & 383-163 yd edges). Earlier this year UW went into SLC as a 4<sup>th</sup> pt favorite and came away with a solid 21-7 victory holding the Utes to a ssn-low in both points (avg 31 ppg TY) and yards (avg 415 ypg in '18). In fact, 5 of the 6 P12 matchups have gone in favor of the Huskies with a 29-21 avg score. Ironically UW's win over Utah was the only P12 game that they've covered as a favorite during the entire '18 campaign with 7 consec ATS losses as chalk occurring since that Wk 3 matchup (+8 ppg & +78 ypg in conf play). While the Utes are a P12 dog for just the 3rd time TY (1-1 ATS), they have covered 6 of their past 7 matchups inside of the conf coming in (+10 ppg & +63 ypg in conf play). However, injuries could play a critical role in this one as not only has Utah been using a rFr QB as their starter following the loss of Huntley, but they're also missing RB Moss who surpassed the 1,000 yard rushing mark prior to being lost for the year. With previous experience in this matchup, a 4th year starting QB under center and recent success in their meetings with the Utes, the Huskies get the call to claim their 2nd P12 Title! **FORECAST: Washington by 10**

## Friday November 30th

### MAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - FORD FIELD - DETROIT, MI

**Northern Illinois by 3 over Buffalo** - The Bulls came into LW needing to win to secure their spot and after leading BG just 13-7 after 1Q pulled away to lead 34-7 at HT & 44-7 early 4Q in a 44-14 win. This is just Buffalo's 2nd MAC Championship appearance, but they did upset #12 Ball St to win the 2008 MAC Title. NIU actually "clinched" their berth here, when WM lost to Ohio on Nov 1st. They back into the conference title game as they were upset in their final 2 regular season games, losing 13-7 (-7) at home to Miami & 28-21 (-6.5) at WM LW. The Huskies are making their MAC best, 8th appearance in this game, but their first since playing in 6 straight from '10-'15. They are just 3-4 SU in the Championship game last winning the Title in 2014. NIU HC Carey does have the edge here as he coached the Huskies in their last 3 trips here as UB HC Leipold is making his first, but Carey did go just 1-2 in those games (all vs BG). Leipold does have post ssn experience, as he led Wisconsin Whitewater to SEVEN Div III Championship games winning 6. Against their 6 common MAC foes UB was 5-1 SU & ATS winning and covering all 5 as the favorite. NIU was 5-1 SU but 3-3 ATS going 2-3 as a favorite. In those gms NIU won by an avg 26-19 outgaining foes by an average 387-313. Buffalo won by an avg 32-28 outgaining foes by an average 434-410. This is a classic offense vs defense as UB has a huge offensive edge (#53-#113), while NIU has a huge defensive edge (#27-#81). UB has opened as a 3<sup>rd</sup> pt favorite, so since the saying goes "Defense wins championships", we will take the Huskies & the points as in their only other MAC game as a dog TY, NIU beat EM 26-23 as a 3 pt AD. **Saturday December 1st**

### AAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BRIGHOUSE NETWORK STADIUM - ORLANDO, FL

**Memphis by 1 over UCF** - This is the fourth meeting the last two years and a rematch of last years AAC Title game. Memphis hosted UCF on October 13th & led 30-17 with a 339-237 yard edge at halftime, but was shutout in the second half and lost 31-30 (+5). The Tigers did finish with 27-18 first down and 490-461 yard edges. UCF has won 12 in a row SU in the series and since 2009 the home team in this series is 7-0-1 ATS. Memphis is +99 ypg in AAC play, but -82 ypg away, while UCF is +81 ypg in AAC play and +147 ypg at home. Against four common foes (Navy/ UConn/EC/SMU) Memphis is 3-1 SU/ATS, +17 ppg and +130 ypg, while UCF is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS, +26 ppg and +110 ypg. We used UCF as a 2★ on these pages last week (also a Friday College Marquee) in their costly War on I-4 rivalry win as star QB McKenzie Milton suffered a gruesome leg injury (OFY). Darriel Mack completed just 5-14-81-0-0, but did rush for 51 (5.1). Mack started

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at East Carolina on October 20th (Milton inj) and went 12-20-69-0-0, but ran for 120 (5.5). Memphis needed to beat Houston last week to advance here and we won a **4★ LPS** play on the Tigers in their 21 point win. RB Darrell Henderson set the AAC single season rush record (1699, 8.6l) after finishing with 178 (7.4). In the prior meeting Henderson ran for 199 (6.4). Memphis has the edge on defense and special teams, while we'll also give the Tigers the edge on offense due to Milton's injury. The Tigers strength is their run game (276, 6.4), which UCF struggles to defend (all'g 212, 4.5). Memphis is 8-4-1 as an AD & is on a 12-4 overall ATS run. We'll call for Memphis to end the long series losing streak, while also ending UCF's 24 game winning streak.

### SUN BELT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - KIDD-BREWSTER STADIUM - BOONE, NC

**APPALACHIAN ST by 14 over Louisiana** - First ever SBC title game. App St has dominated this series, winning the 5 previous mtgs by a combined score of 177-54 (avg MOV 25 ppg). They met this season already here and the Cajuns (+25) only trailed 17-10 at the half in a 27-17 loss. In that game (**3★** newsletter winner) App St held LA's offensive attack (448 ypg) to 136 yds under their season avg. App St won 21-10 vs Troy at home last week (held Trojans to 232 total yds) and have ran for over 200 yards in 8 of their last 9. LA beat rival ULM 31-28 last week to get here as ULM missed a game tying FG as time expired and LA has ran for over 200 yards in 8 of their last 10. Against 6 common SBC foes App St was 6-0 SU & 5-0-1 ATS and were +170 ypg & +26 ppg while LA was 4-2 SU & 2-2-2 ATS and were +2 ypg & +5 ppg. LA's strength is their RB trio of Ragas (1,040 yds, 5.7 ypc, 8 TD), Mitchell (866 yds, 7.1 ypc, 12 TD) and Calais (711 yds, 9.4 ypc, 6 TD) as LA avg's 230 ypg (5.8) on the ground, but App St's run defense has given up just 124 ypg (3.5 ypc) and in the last 4 gms that number improved to 104 ypg allowed (3.4 ypc). App St may have a stronger run game (242 ypg, 5.8 ypg) as RB Evans (968 yds, 6.5 ypc) has done well replacing Jain Moore (OFY midseason) and LA allows 208 rush ypg (4.9 ypc). App St QB Thomas is a true dual-threat as he hits 63.6% of passes (18-4 ratio) and has ran for 417 yds (5.6 ypc). App St holds foes to 104 ypg under their season avg (#10) while LA allows foes 54 ypg more than their season avg (#107). LA gains 529 ypg at home, but just 368 ypg on the road, while App St gives up just 271 ypg at home this year. App St has a large edge in defense (#38 vs #118) and in special teams (#15 vs #76), but LA is 28-16-1 as an AD and 4-0-1 on the road this year, while App St is 8-14-2 as home chalk.

### SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - MERCEDES-BENZ STADIUM - ATLANTA, GA

**Alabama by 11 over Georgia** - Rematch of LY's National Title game and possibly a defacto playoff game. Bama won this game from '14-'16 (2-1 ATS) but didn't win the SEC West LY. HC Saban is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in SEC Title gms. These 2 also met in the '12 SEC Title gm with Bama winning 32-28 (-7). UGA is ply'g in their 2nd str SEC Title gm after beating Aub 28-7 (E) LY. We picked up a **4★ LPS** winner on Bama LW in their 52-21 (-24). QB Tagovailoa threw for 324 yds and 5 td's, bringing his ratio to 31-2 on the ssn! Bama only led 24-21 at half but finished with a 500-283 yd edge. Bama avg 521 ypg in SEC play, but surprisingly only 189 (4.9) rush ypg. We also picked up a **4★ Totals GOY** winner on the OVER in UGA vs GA Tech (Top Totals Play 19-3 L2Y, 86%!!!). Georgia scored on each of their F/7 possessions and GT's only 2 OFF td's came after falling behind 45-7 4Q. UGA avg 233 (5.4) rush ypg in SEC play. They avg 103 ypg more than their foes allow (#8 in FBS) and UGA allows 94 ypg less than their foes avg (#15 in FBS). RB Swift was expected to be the next great UGA RB, but he only avg 51.7 rush ypg (5.1) in his F/7. Since then he's rushed for 120 ypg (8.8) in his L/5. Bama only allows 88 (2.7) rush ypg in SEC play and is led by future NFL draft pick DT Williams (7 sk, 9 tfl, 11 qbh). Bama avg 159 ypg more than their foes allow and also holds foes to 141 ypg below their avg (both #3 in FBS). QB Tagovailoa already faced our #2 and #6 pass eff D's, having compl'd 62% w/a 3-2 ratio vs LSU & MSU. UGA comes in at #41 in our pass eff D but does have CB Baker who is a potential #1 draft choice. HC Smart is 7-1 ATS in neutral site games and UGA has cov'd their L/4 as dogs, so we lean with the Dawgs.

### MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - ALBERTSONS STADIUM - BOISE, ID

**BOISE ST by 6 over Fresno St** - This is the 4th mtg between these schools in just over 1 calendar year, 3 of them have been on the Blue Turf. These team met in last season's regular season finale at Fresno & after Boise cut the lead to 19-17 mid 4th quarter, Fresno got an 81-yd TD pass to go up 26-17 just 20 seconds later and then sacked Boise QB Rypien for a safety and won 28-17. A week later these teams met for the MW title, but it was in Boise despite Fresno winning the head-to-head battle. Fresno went up 14-10 at HT & the score stayed that way until late 4Q when Boise got the GW TD run with 4:42 left. TY Fresno traveled to Boise & led 17-3 at the half. But Boise would go on to score 3 TD's in the 2H vs a stout Fresno defense & won 24-17. Boise is off a 33-24 home win vs Utah St while Fresno won 31-13 over San Jose St. Against 4 common MW foes this ssn (Wyoming/Nevada/N.Mexico/San Diego St) Boise is 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS and is +120 ypg & +12 ppg while Fresno is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS and is +94 ypg & +21 ppg. Fresno has the #7 pass defense (17 int's, 58 pbu's), while Boise has the #11 passing attack (306 ypg) led by QB Rypien (3,580 yds, 68.8%, 29-7 ratio). Boise has the #103 pass defense & will face QB McMurry who is #4 FBS in comp percentage (70.5%) & has a 24-3 ratio and also faces stud WR KeeSean Johnson who has 1,267 yds (#7 FBS) and 8 TD's this year. Boise holds foes to 45 ypg under their season avg (#36), while Fresno holds foes to 73 ypg under their season avg (#25) and their only game of allowing over 400 yds was vs Boise. Boise will have the crowd on their side & make it tough on Fresno. These teams have played 3 close games in a row & we don't see that changing in this matchup.

### ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BANK OF AMERICA STADIUM - CHARLOTTE, NC

**Clemson by 31 over Pittsburgh** - The last time these 2 met, Pitt was a 3 td dog and handed Clemson their only loss in the National Title ssn of '16, 42-41. Clemson is playing in their 4th straight ACC Title game, and they are 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in those. Pitt is the sixth different team in the L6Y to win the ACC Coastal Div (first time that's happened in FBS history), and the Panthers are playing in their first ACC Title gm. Clemson was the clear fav to win the ACC this year, returning 15 starters from a playoff team. The Tigers had 2 close wins in their F/5, beating A&M by 2 pts and Cuse by 5 pts then Clemson rolled their L/7 foes by 39.1 ppg! Clem is +274 ypg in ACC play and their DL, which is loaded with NFL talent, allows 85 (2.2) rush ypg. Pitt entered '18 with 13 ret starters and started the ssn just 3-4 and a 2nd str bowl-less ssn looked likely. The Panthers won their next 4, incl outright upsets over Duke & UVA, to clinch the Coastal. We went against Pitt LW and picked up a **3★ LPS** winner, with Pitt losing to revenge-minded Miami 24-3 (+5). In ACC play Pitt avg 261 (6.3) rush ypg. The Tigers lead the nation in Def YPP (3.77) and they hold foes to 131 ypg below their avg (#5 in FBS). The Tigers did allow 600 yds vs SC LW, but 510 of that came through the air and Pitt QB Pickett has topped 200 yds just once all ssn. Pitt holds foes to 29 ypg below their avg (#48 in FBS) but in their toughest test, all'd 568 at UCF, and also 619 vs Duke. Clem RB Etienne is a Walker Award Finalist (1,307 rush, 8.0) and faces a Pitt D that allows 188 (4.9) rush but has also given up 200+ rush on 5 occasions, incl 293 (9.2) LW at Miami. Clemson on a 6-0-1 ATS run and is 10-1 ATS in Neutral Site gms, so we don't mind laying the pts on the playoff-bound Tigers.

**BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LUCAS OIL STADIUM - INDIANAPOLIS, IN**

**Ohio State by 13 over Northwestern** - The B10 Title game began in 2011 and Northwestern is making their first appearance while this will be Ohio State's fourth, including second straight. This is the first meeting since a 24-20 (-26') Buckeye win in 2016. Ohio State had won four straight meetings by 43.5 ppg, however each of the last two has been one possession games in the fourth quarter. In B10 play Ohio State is +12 ppg and +120 ypg, while Northwestern is +6 ppg and -27 ypg. Against six common foes (RU/MN/PU/Neb/MSU/Mich) Ohio State is +14 ppg and +138 ypg, while Northwestern is +5 ppg and -29 ypg. The Buckeyes were a home 'dog under HC Urban Meyer for the first time last week and responded with their best game of the season in blowing out arch rival Michigan 62-39 (+4). It was the most points by the Buckeyes in series history and the most points the Wolverines ever allowed in regulation. Northwestern has played to the level of their competition all season and last week was no different, which is why we went against them on these pages, winning a 3★ in their 24-16 (-17) victory vs Illinois. Ohio State QB Dwayne Haskins broke Drew Brees' B10 record with 41 td passes and he leads an offense that is #2 FBS averaging 165 ypg more than their foes allow. Northwestern will have the edge on defense, while the Buckeyes have a large edge on special teams and has big game experience. True frosh RB Isaiah Bowser has emerged for the 'Cats in the second half of the season, averaging 122 (4.6) rush ypg over the last six games, while Ohio State is allowing 193 (5.5) rush ypg away from home. QB Clayton Thorson is an NFL prospect and while the Buckeyes are a respectable #37 in our pass efficiency defense ranking, that is their worst since 2013 and they've allowed a 16-9 ratio. Sure Ohio State needs style points to make the playoffs and the last time they were in this role they dominated Wisconsin 59-0 in the 2014 B10 Title game, however they were a dog. The Buckeyes have covered just two of their last eight games, while Northwestern is on a 13-2-1 run as a dog with 10 outright upsets the last three years. We'll call for the 'Cats to keep it close.

**NC STATE by 28 over East Carolina** - This game was scheduled as a replacement due to both schools having games cancelled in September due to weather. East Carolina is on a 3-0 SU/ATS series run with the last meeting taking place in '16. The last time here (2013) the Pirates won 42-28 (-6'). These schools are trending in opposite directions as NC State has won three of four, while East Carolina has lost six of seven. The Pirates are travelling for the third time in four weeks and with no postseason opportunity, appear to have packed it in based on last weeks 56-6 (+18) loss at Cincinnati. NC State meanwhile, is still playing for bowl positioning. East Carolina's defense held five of their first six foes under their season average, but three of their last four foes have all gone well over their season average including Cincinnati finishing with 641 last week. The Pirates are +118 ypg at home, but -145 away, while NC State is +79 ypg at home. Each has a win over North Carolina, but East Carolina's came in the second week of the season when many Tarheel players were suspended. NC State ran for 206 yards last week in their win at North Carolina and the Pirates are allowing 219 (5.0) rush ypg their last five games. QB Ryan Finley has thrown for 3,380 (67%, 21-8) and East Carolina is #114 in our pass

efficiency defense ranking (28-4 ratio!). East Carolina is on a 11-27 overall ATS run, is 4-12 as an AD and 3-15 as a regular season dog of 7+ points. NC State is on a 20-12 ATS run as chalk and is 10-4 ATS vs non-conference FBS foes. We'll call for NC State to win in dominant fashion.

**SOUTH CAROLINA by 31 over Akron** - This game was added due to both teams having a game cancelled earlier TY. Akron comes in off 4 straight DD losses vs MAC foes. LW the Zips (+24) fell behind 21-0 1Q at Ohio, yet they only trailed 42-28 4Q and Ohio's last td came with just :05 left. QB Nelson did throw for 356 yds and 4 td's but once again Akron failed to run the ball, avg just 51.8 (1.9) rush ypg in their L/4. SC is off a 21 pt loss in the Palmetto Bowl. The 'Cocks only trailed 28-21 at half but lost 56-35 (+26) with Clem's last td coming with :39 left. SC put up the most yds Clem has all'd all year w/600. QB Bentley threw for 510 yds and 5 td's and now has a 17-4 ratio since returning from inj earlier TY. Akron comes in at #63 in our pass eff D, having allowed just 10 pass td's TY. SC has a huge edge on OFF, avg 63 ypg more than their foes allow (#27 in FBS) while the Zips avg 107 ypg less than foes allow (#127 in FBS). The Gamecocks also have a solid edge in ST's (#15 vs #63) and naturally they've ply'd the much tougher sked (#16 vs #95). Akron did cover at 2 P5 foes TY incl their upset win at NW, but their motivation won't be the same here and SC will end their home slate with a resounding victory.

**Stanford by 1 over CALIFORNIA** - This will mark the 121st "Big Game" with Stanford & Cal meeting every year s/1946. It is however being played a few weeks later than expected with the originally scheduled matchup (Nov 17th) being scratched due to the devastation of the California Wildfires. Following 4 losses in a 5-gm span from the beginning of Oct to the start of Nov, the Cardinal have rebounded the past 2 weeks in victories over OSU and LW at UCLA where QB Costello threw for 344 yds and a career-best 5 TD's. Cal meanwhile has now claimed victories in 4 of their past 5 (4-0-1 ATS) following their 12 pt win LW in Berkeley against the Buifs (ssn-high 5 forced TO's incl a pair of pick-6's). While the Cardinal have won 8 straight (6-2 ATS) in this series by 20 ppg, LY's meeting saw them claim just a 3 pt home win as 14 pt chalk. With Cal continuing to play opponents tough (all'g just 319 ypg on the yr), we'll give the visitor only the slightest of edges in this one.

**VIRGINIA TECH by 1 over Marshall** - This game was added conditionally based on VT's ability to make a bowl game. The Hokies extended their winning streak over UVA last week, winning 34-31 in OT (+4). The Hokies crowd made a huge difference and VT led 14-0 at half and held a 197-106 yd edge. UVA rallied and led 31-24 4Q but the Hokies got a td after RB Peoples fumbled into the EZ. Marshall also enters off a win, beating FIU 28-25 (-3') despite getting out'd by 61 yds. MU led 21-10 3Q but 2 of Marshall's F/3 td's came on a pick-6 and a blk'd punt for td. The Herd were w/o their top 2 RB's King & Anderson, but true frosh RB Knox went for 109 yds which was his 2nd 100-yd effort in his L/3. Marshall has a significant edge on defense, holding foes to 50 ypg below their avg (33 in FBS) while VT allows 51 ypg more than their foes avg (#105 in FBS). VT has the edge on OFF, avg 25 ypg more than their foes allow (#48 in FBS). QB Willis has an 18-8 ratio but has compl'd just 46%, 2-4 ratio in his L/2. MU avg 11 ypg less than their foes allow. QB Green missed 3 gms with inj. Since he returned, he's compl'd 57% w/a 6-3 ratio. Marshall is 5-0 as an AD. VT is 1-5 ATS at home vs FBS foes.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ PITTSBURGH over LA Chargers - SNF** - This marks the only Heinz Field matchup in a 4-wk span for PIT who returns from DEN after seeing their 6-gm winning streak snapped (-4 TO's). The Chargers meanwhile appeared to be looking ahead early on LW vs ARZ (trailed 10-0 after 1Q) before scoring 45 unanswered pts in the easy victory (QB Rivers NFL record with 25 consecutive completions to start the gm). In their most recent matchup on MNF in SD ('15), bkp QB Michael Vick (Big Ben inj'd) led a late 12pl/80yd drive that ended with the GW 1-yd TD run on the game's final play (24-20 PIT win, +3). While the Chargers have dominated sub-.500 competition in '18, their 2 matchups against the NFL's elite (KC & LAR) saw them lose both by DD's. With PIT's recent home success worth noting (outscored the past 3 foes by 23 ppg), they get the call in this one against an LA squad (RB Gordon likely out) that's playing at night in potentially freezing temps. **FORECAST: PITTSBURGH by 13**

**3★ SEATTLE over San Francisco** - While the 49ers entered the '18 ssn on a 7-2 ATS run against DIV foes, the current year hasn't been as favorable with 3 SU & ATS losses by 11 ppg. They now head on the road for a 2nd consec week following an 18 pt loss in Tampa (just 9 pts despite 342 yds of offense). The Seahawks also made a trip East a week ago to Charlotte where they came away with a crucial comeback win against the Panthers (GW 31-yd FG as time expired). While SEA is 2-7-1 ATS as a HF entering this matchup, an 8-0 SU (7-1 ATS) mark against the 49ers (12 pt avg MOV) and renewed playoff hope has us leaning in their direction against a rookie QB making his 1st career start in front of the "12th Man". **FORECAST: SEATTLE by 17**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Buffalo (+) over MIAMI** - The Dolphins nearly ended the Colts' winning streak a wk ago in their return from bye with IND connecting on a GW 32-yd FG as time expired (QB Tannehill 17-25-204-2-0 in return from inj). MIA now returns home to take on a BUF squad that picked up a pair of victories a yr ago in the series incl a 22-16 ssn finale win in South Beach. The Bills have picked up 2 consec wins heading to South Beach following a 41-10 victory against the Jets prior to their bye and a 24-21 win a wk ago against the Jags in the return of QB Allen from inj (160 pass, 99 rush, 2 TD). Despite a relatively solid 6-2 ATS mark in home matchups coming in, a 1 pt lean is all that we can give MIA in this one as they've covered just 3 of their past 10 inside of the DIV. **FORECAST: MIAMI by 1**

## OTHER PLAYS

**New Orleans at DALLAS - Thursday** - The streak continued last Thur for the Saints as they earned a 14 pt victory over the Falcons (outscored the past 2 NFC Champs by a 79-24 margin the L2 wks) to extend their SU (10-0) and ATS (9-0) runs. The Cowboys meanwhile have moved into 1st place in the NFC East following their 3rd consec SU & ATS win on Thanksgiving against the Redskins (WR Cooper 180 rec yds & 2 TD). While a 3-gm road trip can be tough for any NFL squad, the Saints should be extremely confident with a perfect 5-0 SU/ATS mark so far in '18 (15 pt avg cover). The Cowboys will however be one of their tougher tests away from home as they've won 4 of 5 in Arlington TX. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**Indianapolis by 7 over JACKSONVILLE** - Following their 5th consec win (3-1-1 ATS) a week ago at home against the Dolphins (32-yd GW FG as time expired) where QB Luck threw for 3+ TD's yet again (8th straight), the Colts head to JAX seeking the ssn sweep for the 1st time since 2014 after they held off a late charge (led 29-13) by the Jags less than a month ago (JAX 24-17 FD & 415-366 yd edges). The Jaguars' surprising ssn of despair continued LW in BUF as the Bills became the latest team to earn playoff revenge from the year prior with a 3 pt victory (QB Bortles another poor performance hitting just 12-23 for 127 yds & 1-2 ratio). With the Colts needing a win here to stay within reach of the front-running Texans who they visit next week, we'll go ahead and call for them to improve upon their already solid 5-2-1 ATS mark as a favorite.

**Carolina by 1 over TAMPA BAY** - The Panthers saw their 10-gm winning streak in Charlotte snapped a week ago against the Seahawks who scored 10 pts in the final 3:26 for the comeback victory (SEA 31 yd FG as time expired, CAR 476-398 yd edge). Unfortunately their true tests have come on the road so far in '18 as they head to Tampa with just a 1-6 SU & ATS mark that also dates back to a year ago. The Bucs meanwhile continued to swap QB's at an alarming rate with Winston the latest to earn a start a week ago at home against the 49ers (312 pass yds & 2 TD in the 18 pt victory). In their matchup a month ago in CAR, the Panthers jumped out to an early 35-7 lead before TB stormed back to cut to 35-28 (CAR scored final TD to win by 14). With the previously mentioned road issues for the Panthers and the Bucs covering 7 in a row as a HD, a 1 pt lean is all that we can muster up for the visitor in this one.

**Baltimore by 6 over ATLANTA** - The Falcons return home following a 14 pt loss in the "Big Easy" that has all but eliminated them from playoff contention in the NFC (QB Ryan led ATL with just 16 rush yds vs the Saints!). They now welcome a Ravens squad that's right in the mix for a postseason berth after a 2nd consec home win a week ago against the Raiders that was aided by 70-yd PR & 46-yd FR TD's (held OAK to just 13 FD & 249 yds). While BAL has had their share of issues against non-conf foes with just a 2-9 ATS mark, the Falcons haven't had much success in that role either at just 5-19 ATS including an 0-3 SU/ATS mark in '18 (12 pt avg defeat). With playoff need playing an important role for the visitor, we expect them to get the job done here before their trip to Arrowhead next weekend.

**HOUSTON by 7 over CLEVELAND** - While the Texans were an outstanding 8-1 ATS as a NDIV HF from '15-'17, they've been a bit shaky in that role this year with just a 1-3 ATS mark. The Browns meanwhile ended their 25-game road losing skid in commanding fashion LW in CIN (QB Mayfield 4 TD passes). In LY's trip to HOU, the Texans jumped out to a 24-3 HT lead en route to a 16 pt victory (-7, 340-247 yd edge). Despite being on short rest coming in following their MNF matchup against the Titans, the Browns' 5-11 ATS mark as a NDIV AD has us siding with the home team in this one.

**Chicago by 7 over NY GIANTS** - Although the Bears entered '18 with an outstanding 8-2-1 ATS run as a NDIV AF, they haven't fared too well in that role so far TY with an 0-2 ATS mark that includes an outright upset in MIA back in Oct. Following another defensive-led effort on Thanksgiving against the Lions where a pair of int's (incl a 4Q pick-6) allowed them to escape with a 23-16 win (5th consec cover), they do get some extra rest before this trip to hopefully get QB Trubisky back under center (missed their matchup against DET, bkp Daniel 27-37-230-2-0). With 19 pts & 346 yds in the 1H LW against PHI, the Giants looked well on their way to a 3rd consec win. Unfortunately some questionable play-calling in the 2H (held to just 3 pts & 56 yds) allowed PHI to come back and hit the GW FG w/22 left. While the Giants have failed to cover 7 of their past 10 as a HD, we'll ride with the Bears as they look to stay on track before key home matchups on deck against the Rams & Packers.

**Denver by 8 over CINCINNATI** - While the Broncos were on just a 1-10 road ATS run heading into their Oct 18th matchup against the Cardinals, their fortunes have changed since with a perfect 3-0 ATS mark that includes an outright upset of the Chargers (+7) just 2 wks ago. They now find themselves back in playoff contention after a 2nd straight outright upset LW at home against the Steelers (527-308 yd deficit, +4 TO's). The Bengals meanwhile took a major hit in their playoff hopes in LW's dismal home effort against the Browns (trailed 35-7 Mid 3Q). In their trip to "Mile High" a ssn ago, the Bengals (+2 TO's) earned a 20-17 upset victory despite significant deficits in both FD's (20-12) and yds (341-190). With 2 key offensive contributors uncertain here (QB Dalton & WR Green) for the Bengals along with major inconsistency on the defensive end (#31 at 31.2 ppg & DEAD LAST all g 449 ypg), we expect the Broncos to continue their recent success away from home.

**LA Rams by 6 over DETROIT** - Despite having a 13-9 lead in the 4Q and a 333-264 yd edge overall, the Lions were unable to get the job done LW at home on Thanksgiving against a Trubisky-less Bears squad who saw their defense step to the forefront once again with a pair of key int's in the final frame that included a 41-yd pick-6 with 6 minutes remaining. The Lions now have a little bit of extra time to prepare for a well-rested Rams squad that heads to "Motown" following their week off (8-2-1 ATS after a bye). In their Ford Field matchup back in '16, the Lions (-3) needed a GW 34-yd FG with 1:29 left to escape with a 31-28 win (Rams 387-348 yd edge). While the Rams are clearly in the upper echelon of the league at the moment sitting at 10-1 overall, their ability to cover a 7+ pt spread has been lacking with just a 1-5 ATS run as significant chalk coming in.

**GREEN BAY by 21 over ARIZONA** - After being held to less than 300 yds of offense for the 14th time in 15 gms a week ago against the Chargers who scored the game's final 45 pts (ARZ led 10-0 after 1Q), the Cardinals head North to Lambeau. The Packers need to win out in order to potentially earn a playoff bid following LW's loss to the Vikings where they were held to a ssn-low 254 yds (399 ypg coming in). In their most recent meetings back in '15, the Cardinals not only blew out the Packers in the regular ssn by a 38-8 score but also got past them in OT during the playoffs (Rodgers Hail Mary on final play to tie the game!). With potentially frigid temps welcoming ARZ in this one and GB thumping their last warm-weathered visitor (MIA) by a 31-12 score just a few wks back, a win by 3 TD's is possible.

**Kansas City by 17 over OAKLAND** - Following a memorable MNF shootout against the Rams (only team in NFL history to score 50+ pts in a loss) and a much needed bye week, the Chiefs return to action riding an impressive 13-2 ATS streak. The Raiders meanwhile return home after a lackluster effort a wk ago in BAL where they were held to just 249 yds in a 17 pt defeat. In LY's trip to the "Black Hole" the Raiders ended their 5-gm losing skid to the Chiefs thanks in part to a 417 yd, 3 TD passing effort from QB Carr. However, with KC HC Reid 16-3 SU following a bye week and the Chiefs having covered 12 of their past 15 inside of the DIV, don't expect a repeat performance in the Bay Area this time around (OAK 1-6-1 ATS as a HD & 5-10 ATS vs AFC West).

**TENNESSEE by 14 over NY Jets** - It's been a rough stretch for the Jets as they head into Nashville with 5 consec SU & ATS losses (15 avg loss) following LW's home loss to the Patriots where they were gashed for 200+ yds on the ground for a 2nd straight contest. The Titans meanwhile return home on short rest after their MNF tilt against the Texans. In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Titans trailed 27-0 at HT in the eventual 22 pt defeat inside of MetLife (NYJ 439-292 yd edge). With TEN an outstanding 12-2-2 ATS at home and the Jets on just a 4-11-2 ATS run as an AD, we'll side with the Titans in this one as they continue to fight for a playoff berth in the AFC.

**NEW ENGLAND by 3 over Minnesota** - This marks the only HG in a 4-wk span for the Patriots who got back into the win column LW against the Jets behind 498 yds of ti offense including a ssn-best 215 on the ground (avg 108 rush ypg coming in). The schedule hasn't been any easier for the Vikings since their bye week return as they head to Foxboro following a pair of SNF matchups against the Bears (5 pt loss) and Packers (7 pt win, QB Cousins 342 yds & 3 TD). While the Vikings have yet another tough road test on deck as they travel to Seattle for MNF, we'll call for them to stay within a FG as a loss here could prove costly in their bid for a postseason berth (NE 14-4 ATS run vs NFC foes).

**Washington at PHILADELPHIA - MNF** - Following an 8 pt loss in Dallas on Thanksgiving where bkp QB McCoy was forced into a trio of int's in his 1st start for the inj'd Smith, the Redskins head to Philly with a good amount of extra rest to take on an Eagles squad that earned the ssn sweep of WAS a year ago en route to their 1st SB title (13 & 11 pt victories). After a dismal 41 pt defeat a week earlier in the Superdome against the Saints, the Eagles moved within a game of 1st place in the NFC East (DAL & WAS tied atop at 6-5) with a 3 pt comeback victory over the Giants (GW 43-yd FG w/22 left). While WAS remains one of the most injury-plagued tms in the league (especially on their OL), keep in mind that PHI is just 8-18-1 ATS as a DIV HF coming into this matchup.
