2★ ARMY over Middle Tennessee - First meeting. This will be played in front of the Corps only. Middle Tenn doesn't get the normal advantage of having all spring and summer to prep for the option. This game wasn't added to their schedule until August 10th. The Blue Raiders look to bounce back after rare losing campaign under Rick Stockstill. The last time MT finished with a losing record they went 8-4 the following season. MT is led by QB Asher O'Hara who rushed for 1,058 (5.3) last year and should be an improved passer as a 2nd year starter (63%, 20-8). They added 2 Power-5 transfer RB's but both opted out along with a starting OL. Army has 12 starters back including 7 on a defense that only allowed 23 ppg and 342 ypg. The Black Knights must replace their starting QB but backups Christian Anderson and Jabari Laws both started games last year. Stockstill hasn't faced the option since 2013 (24-6 loss vs Navy in bowl) and with limited prep time the Blue Raiders will have a tough time stopping the Black Knights option attack so we see Army winning by double-digits.

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 3rd

South Alabama at SOUTHERN MISS - These campuses are only 93 miles apart yet this is their first meeting. SMISS looks to bounce back after closing '19 out poorly, losing their last 3 by 17 ppg. The Golden Eagles had 14 starters returning but 3 starters including 2 All-CUSA defenders opted out. S Alabama only won 2 games last year but should be vastly improved with 15 starters back including QB Trotter who had an 8-2 ratio LY. SMISS has the talent edge and QB Abraham should have a bounce back year and the Jaguars were only #116 in our Pass Defense rankings LY. The Golden Eagles did lose as a HF 2 years ago vs SBC foe ULM. SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 5th

MEMPHIS by 14 over Arkansas St - Schools have met 57 times, with Memphis holding a 29-23-5 series lead. As of presstime Memphis is allowing a small number of fans into the stadium. These teams last met in 2013, and the Red Wolves (-3) fell to Memphis 31-7. Despite losing their starting QB 4 games into LY Ark St still threw for 312 ypg, which ranked 10th in the FBS, and they return both QB's this season and 9 OFF starters overall. Memphis finished 2019 with the #35 pass defense & they return 6 players in their secondary who have start exp as well as an Auburn transfer. Ark St's DEF was hit hard with inj LY and allowed 478 ypg (#124 FBS) and must face a Memphis offense that returns 5 starters incl QB Brady White (4014 yds, 64%, 33-11) and WR Damonte Coxie (1276 yds, 9 td) but All-American TB Kenneth Gainwell (1459 rush yds, 610 rec yds) opted out this week. Both teams have talented offenses, Memphis appears to have the stronger defense with 8 starters back. While Ark St is 0-3 ATS as a double digit underdog the L2Y, the sudden loss of Gainwell has us capping our lean on Memphis to two TD's.

Smu by 24 over TEXAS ST - Third meeting. These schools met LY with SMU (-17) coming away with a 47-17 win last year at home where they outgained TXSt 639-242 incl 390 rushing yds. SMU does have to replace their top 2 rushers, but bring back 4 of their top 6 receivers and a talented JUCO WR. SMU also brings back talented QB Buechele, who threw for 3,929 yds (62.7%, 34-10) LY. TXSt's pass defense finished #106 LY and only return 2 str's in the secondary. Overall TXSt returns just 4 str's to a defense that allowed 417 ypg & 32.6 ppg LY and TXSt must replace all 3 starting LB's from LY. TXSt does return 8 str's on offense and should be better in year two under offensive-minded HC Spavital after avg'g just 318 yds & 18.4 pts LY. TXSt will not have much of a home field edge with just 25% of fans allowed as of presstime. TXSt is just 4-13 ATS as a HD against FBS foes the L4Y and with no real home field edge, we will side with SMU by over 3 TD's.

MONDAY SEPTEMBER 7th

Byu at NAVY - Third meeting, but first since 1989 when BYU (-11) travelled to Navy and won 31-10. BYU will not have a lot of time to prep for Navy's triple option as this game was announced on Aug 6th. BYU dealt with a lot of injuries to their offense last year, but return 8 starters on offense incl QB Zach Wilson, and 5 OL that started at least 7 gms LY. BYU also returns 12 of their top 14 tkl'rs from a DEF that allowed 18.3 ppg the L/6 reg ssn games. Navy returns 13 starters to a team that went 11-2 a year ago and averaged an FBS-best 361 rush ypg. While Navy loses their star QB Malcolm Perry (2017 rush yds, 6.8 ypc, 21 td) they bring back their top 3 RB's as well as 5 of their top 8 tkl'rs from a DEF that gave up 314 ypg (#16 FBS) last ssn. BYU has a significant edge in experience (#15 vs. #107) but does have to travel to Navy, however will play this game in front of no crowd. Remember on Monday Nights you can get a \$back+ guarantee! FBS/FCS WK 1 GAMES

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 3rd

UAB by 28 over Central Arkansas - First meeting, the Blazers are 4-0 vs FCS foes under Bill Clark, winning by 28 ppg. The Blazers are the clear favorites to win the CUSA and one of the most experienced FBS teams in the country with 18 starters

back including their top passer, top rusher, top WR and top 5 tkl'rs. C Ark has a game-under-belt edge after beating Austin Peay 24-17 last Saturday but is also on short rest. The Bears trailed 17-16 late 4Q then went on a 78 yd/6 play drive and got the GW td w/:34 left. C Ark has an explosive offense that avg'd 293 pass ypg last year and returns their top QB and 4 of their top WR's. UAB returns all 4 starters in the secondary after finishing #27 in our pass defense rankings last year. UAB won't take C Ark lightly considering the Bears upset WKU last year in the opener.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 5th

MARSHALL by 17 over Eastern Kentucky - The last meeting came in '18's opener, Marshall won 32-16, but only led by a td in the 3rd quarter. Marshall has won 9 straight over FCS foes by 31 ppg but are only 2-5-1 ATS in those games. The Colonels return 11 starters from last year's 7-5 squad (+39 ypg). They lose their 1st Tm All-OVC RB and 6 of their top 10 tkl'rs are gone. Marshall has 13 starters back including QB Isaiah Green who entered the portal then returned in August. The Herd have much tougher games looming against ECU & App St, while ECU will be motivated to try to pull their first upset over an FBS squad since 2014.

NORTHTEXAS by 21 over Houston Baptist - First meeting, NT has won 4 straight over FCS foes by 32 ppg but HBU nearly upset UTEP in last year's opener, 36-34 loss. The Mean Green return 12 starters but their biggest question is at quarterback where they must replace the school's all-time leading passer. HBU has 15 starters returning including a solid QB (3811, 64%, 35-15), their top 3 RB's, top 2 WR's and their top 4 tkl'rs. The Huskies only won 2 games between '17-'18 but improved to 5-7 last year and -34 ypg. Both squads have experienced head coaches, but NT has 2 new coordinators and lost their chance to develop a starting QB in spring. HBU is more experienced and has plenty of firepower to keep this very closer than expected.

UTEP by 7 over Stephen F Austin - First meeting. UTEP was nearly upset by an FCS foe, Houston Baptist, in their opener last year. SFA has lost their last 10 games vs FBS foes by 48 ppg but most of those came vs Power 5 schools. The Lumberjacks went 3-9 last year (-90 ypg). This year they do return their QB, top 2 RB's, 2 of their top 4 WR's and 8 of their top 10 tkl'rs. UTEP is one of the least experienced teams in the country with just 10 returning starters after going 1-11 last year (-102 ypg). UTEP will have a small amount of fans attending to support what should be an improved squad in HC Dimel's 3rd year so we give the Miners a 1 td edge.
