ULM allows 253 pass ypg & has the #93 pass eff D that will face an Ark St pass attack that avg's 296 yds & WR Bayless is the FBS leader in rec yds (1,070) and rec TD's (12). ULM does have a solid rush attack led by Josh Johnson (789 yds, 6.6 ypc) & before holding TXSt to 81 rush yds LW, Ark St's run D was giving up 233 ypg. ULM is on an 8-18 ATS slide while Ark St HC Anderson is 24-12 ATS the L/5 years vs SBC foes. We are expecting the Red Wolves to keep rolling along in this series and should have no problem winning by DD's.

FORECAST: Arkansas St by 10

3★ FIU over Old Dominion - The visitor has won the last 2 in this series. FIU trailed 17-0 LY and rallied after weather delay for 28-20 win. FIU had a 3 gm winning streak going into LW but we went against them on these pages, picking up a 2★ winner with FIU losing 50-17 (-2). Middle Tenn put up 471 rush yds and held a 316-31 yd edge in the 2H. We also went against ODU last week on our Saturday Marquees (3 plays for just \$12, call 1-866-654-3448, 3-0 LW!!!) as the Monarchs were crushed by FAU 41-3 (+13). FIU has won 4 straight at home (3-1 ATS) and is +121 ypg at home. ODU is 144 ypg on the road and lost all 4 away games. The Monarchs avg just 180 ypg in CUSA play. HC Wilder has started asking key players to redshirt and inj's have taken a toll. At this point we will just play against ODU who is on a 6-14 ATS run vs CUSA foes.

FORECAST: FIU by 24

3★ Michigan over MARYLAND - It's homecoming in College Park. UM is on a 4-0 SU/ATS series run, winning by 33 ypg & covering by 13 ppg. LY MD had just 42 yds at the half and lost 42-21 (+17). The Wolves are travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks but has a bye on deck and snapped their 8 gm losing streak vs Top 10 tms after beating Notre Dame 45-14 (pk) last week. LB turned RB Haskins ran for a car high 149 yds & UM finished w/437-180 yd & 23-12 FD edges. MD bkp QB Pigrome was inj'd & st'g QB Jackson was still limited (ply'd 1 series) resulting in rFR DeSue getting his most significant ply'g time in their 52-10 (+16) loss at MN. The Terps were out'd 498-210 & outFD'd 30-10. MD is 8-16 as a double-digit dog. The Terps success is determined by the effectiveness of their run game & UM is all'g just 53 (1.6) rush ypg their L/4 gms.

FORECAST: Michigan by 28

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Pittsburgh over GEORGIA TECH - GT has covered 4 of the L/6 in this series though Pitt did pull an outright upset LY 24-19 (+3). The Panthers lost 16-12 (-4) at home in a driving rainstorm LW. Pitt did hold a +114 yd edge but settled for 4 fg's and was -2 TO's. GT enters fresh off a bye following their first ACC win under HC Collins over that same Miami team. GT was fortunate in that game, recovering a fumble in EZ, a fake punt pass td, and UM missed 3 short fg's. Pitt is +35 ypg on the road, having covered all 3 away games. GT is 1-2 SU/0-3 ATS at home and is -106 ypg in those. Pitt allows 86 (2.6) rush ypg and GT still largely relies on their run game (169 ypg, 4.3). Pitt holds foes 100 ypg below their avg (#9 in FBS) and GT avg 32 ypg less than their foes allow (#97 in FBS). GT is improving each week but are 4-10 as a HD and our lean is with the Panthers.

2★ † Georgia over Florida - It's the (formerly known as) World's Largest Cocktail Party! UGA has won the L/2 SU & ATS. LY Florida led 14-13 3Qand was only down 6 in the 4Q then UGA added 2 late 4Q td's. Both tms enter fresh off a bye. Florida is +100 ypg and +55 ypg in SEC play. UGA is +205 ypg and +176 ypg in SEC play. QB Fromm has had his 2 worst performances but the last one did come in a driving rainstorm vs KY. UF allows 125 (3.8) rush ypg but in their L/2 they've given up 218 & 217. The Dawgs avg 237 (6.1) rush ypg. UF does have 29 sks but UGA has allowed just 4 sks on the ssn. UGA is still on a 17-8 ATS run in SEC play so we will lean with the Dawgs by a touchdown.

Georgia Southern at APPALACHIAN ST - App is 3-2 SU/ATS in the series, but are 2-0 SU/ATS at home. The home team is 4-1 ATS in the series. LY App came in ranked for 1st time as FBS tm & lost QB Thomas in 1Q (inj) and fell at GS 34-14 (GS was +5 TO's). App & GS have played 3 common SBC foes (CC, ULL, SAla) and App is 2-1 ATS while GS is 0-3 ATS with App winning those gms by 30.3 pts & it took GS multiple OT's to beat both SAla and CC. App is 3-1 SU/ATS in SBC play, and are outgaining SBC foes by 198 ypg. GS is 2-1 in SBC play SU but are 0-3 ATS and are only outgaining SBC foes by 31 ypg. App's D is holding SBC foes to 250 ypg and their run D is improving, all'g just 107 rush ypg (3.3 ypc) the L/3 gms, but face a GS team avg'g 277 rush yds in SBC play & ran for 403 LW vs NMST. GS all'd 209 rush yds LW to NMST and now face an App rush attack avg'g 308 yds the L/2 gms. App is out for revenge here & come into the gm on an 11-4-1 ATS run vs SBC foes while GS is on a 3-6 ATS slide dating back last ssn.

West Virginia at BAYLOR - While BU is 2-5 SU in the series, they're 5-2 ATS & the host is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS. LY the Bears were held to ssn lows in FD's & ttl yds in the 58-14 (+14) loss. BU lost their F/2 gms after a bye under HC Rhule by a comb'd score of 117-30 and while they did beat Rice 21-13 (-26) earlier this year in that role, they failed to cover. WV is 5-13 ATS off a bye following 3 straight losses. The Bears are 7-0 SU on the strength of their offense. Led by QB Brewer, BU is #12 FBS avg 100 ypg more than their opponents allow. The Mountaineers have struggled to run the ball, avg just 88 (2.9) rush ypg, but the Bears all'd a ssn high 281 (5.6) in their last game. BU is 31-19 as home chalk, but WV is 8-5 ATS on the B12 road.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 1ST

Navy at UCONN - Navy won both prior meetings as AAC rivals & the visitor is 2-0 ATS. The last matchup took place in '16. UConn defended the option 3 weeks ago at Tulane and lost 49-7 (+34), all'g 311 (6.8) rush. The Huskies enter off their first FBS win s/'17 after beating lowly UMass 56-35 (-9). RB Mensah had a car high 5 td's. Navy is bowl elig after their emotional 41-38 (-4) win over Tulane. The Middies failed to hold onto a 24-0 mid 2Q lead and needed a 48 yd fg w/no time left. RB Carothers ran for a car high 154 yds. UConn is 28-19 as a home dog, but Navy is on a 8-2 ATS run. The Huskies are all'g 240 (6.0) rush ypg in conf play, but now that Navy is bowl elig with a bye on deck before facing Notre Dame, will they take UConn lightly?

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 2ND

WAKE FOREST by 10 over Nc state - There have been 9 upsets in this series in the last 22Y. The home tm is 16-4 ATS. LY #22 NCSt was 19' pt chalk at home. QB Newman made first career start and led comeback with GW to pass w/30 left. Both tms are fresh off a bye. The Demon Deacons are +105 ypg on the season, +33 ypg in ACC play and +127 ypg at home. The 'Pack are +61 ypg on the ssn but -47 ypg vs ACC foes and -87 ypg on the road. WF has faced a tougher sked (#82 vs #106). HC Doeren will likely turn to true freshman Devin Leary for his first career start. WF is 0-7 SU/2-5 ATS off a bye but HC Clawson says he's focused on fixing that. We like WF to win by DD. NCSt is on a 2-9 ATS run on the road incl 0-3 SU/ATS this ssn and all 3 losses were by 17+ pts despite being favored in 2 of those. We've got WF by DD's but QB Newman missed the last game and is a ? so there's no line at presstime.

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Liberty by 24 over UMASS - Minutemen won first mtg 62-59 LY in 3OT (gm tied 7 times). In the third OT UMass int'd Liberty in EZ & then on 4th&1 from the LU6 hit GW FG. UMass finished with a 777-488 yd edge incl 540 pass yds. Both faced Rutgers TY. UMass lost in the ssn opener 48-21 as a 16' pt AD being outgained 548-307. Liberty lost LW to a Rutgers' team that was desperate & pulling out all the stops, 44-34 as a 7' pt AF only being outgained 463-413. UMass is off a 56-35 loss to UConn as a 9' pt HD but were only outgained 539-439. The Flames need 2 FBS wins (can only count 1 of 2 wins over FCS) to become bowl eligible and with trips to BYU & Virginia, look for them to pull out all the stops here. UMass just 1-7 SU & ATS (only win vs winless Akron) despite being the dog 7 times including 5x by 16' or over & we look for trend to continue here.

Troy by 4 over COASTAL CAROLINA - Troy is 2-0 SU/ATS vs CC as SBC foes, winning by 24.6 ypg & covering by an avg of 9 pts. LY Troy (-14) went up 21-0 1Q, but CC cut the lead to 10 pts 2 times, but Troy scored the final 14 pts in a 45-21 win. CC is coming off a bye while Troy all'd 579 yds to GS in a 52-33 road loss. CC runs the ball 60% of the time & avg's 196 rush ypg, and up until LW the Troy run D was strong (93 rush ypg) but LW gave up 390 rush yds to GS. CC is giving up 280 rush ypg in SBC play, and their pass eff D is ranked just #112 while Troy QB Barker (2091 yds, 66%, 18-6 ratio) leads a Troy pass OFF that avg's 333 pass yds in SBC play. CC's offense (314 ypg in SBC play) could take adv of a Troy DEF all'g foes to gain 95 yds above their ssn avg (#121 FBS). Teams have 1 common SBC foe (GS) and Troy lost by 19 pts while CC (-4) all'd 472 yds in a 31-21 loss. CC is just 2-8-1 ATS in SBC play the L2Y

Nebraska by 1 over PURDUE - NU is 4-2 SU/2-4 ATS as B10 rivals and the visitor is 5-1 ATS. Half the meetings have resulted in outright upsets! LY PU led 20-7 at HT en route to their first ever win in Lincoln, 42-28 (-3). This is the Boilermakers 3rd home game in 4 wks, but the 'Huskies had a bye 2 weeks ago & has another on deck. NU enters off a 38-31 (-1) home loss vs Indiana where they all'd Hoosier bkp QB Ramsey (LY's st'r) to throw for a car high 351 yds. St'g QB Martinez was out and bkp Vedral was inj'd 2Q before re-entering on the final drive. PU enters off a 24-6 (-9) home loss vs IL, avoiding the shutout after a 99 yd drive mid 4Q. The Boilermakers gained 37% of their ttl yds on that scoring drive and HC Brohm said the QB position will be an open competition. NU is 22-11 ATS away from Lincoln, while PU is 12-23 ATS at home. Neither team gives us confidence here, but we'll call for the Huskers to squeak out the narrow road win.

UCF by 17 over Houston - UCF is 5-3 SU/ATS in the series, but the visitor has covered 4 straight & there has been 3 outright upsets in the 8 matchups. The last meeting was in '16. UH has a bye on deck & enters with a couple of extra days of prep/rest following their 34-31 (+13) loss vs undefeated SMU last Thursday. QB Tune threw for a car high 407 yds as the Cougars finished with a 510-385 yd edge, but were -2 TO's & all'd 7 sks. The Knights only led 28-21 at the half but scored 35 straight in the F/21 minutes of the 2H of their 63-21 (-12) win at Temple last week. RB Anderson ran for a car high 205 yds and UCF finished w/614-266 yd & 24-12 FD edges. UH is 9-2-1 as an away dog. Cougars HC Holgorsen is on a 11-5 SU run in the month of November and for a team that has supposedly 'quit' on the ssn, they sure come to play every week.

INDIANA by 6 over Northwestern - NW is on a 9-1 SU series run and has covered 3 straight. The last meeting was in '16 and this is just the 2nd matchup in the L7Y. This is Indy's 1st home game in a 5 week stretch and they have a bye on deck, but the 'Cats are travelling for the lone time in a 7 week stretch. The Hoosiers enter bowl elig for the 1st time s/'16 following their emotional 38-31 (+1) upset at Nebraska. St'g QB Penix was out, but Peyton Ramsey (LY's st'r) threw for a car high 351 yds as Indy has won 3 straight B10 games in the same ssn for the 1st time s/'93! NW enters on a 5 gm losing skid following their 20-0 (+8) loss vs Iowa, where they were out'd 302-202. NW is 29-10 as an away dog. While these programs are trending in opposite directions, Indy is in uncharted territory under HC Allen already bowl elig, while NW is great as a 'dog under Fitzgerald and the 'Cats are still stingy on defense, holding foes to 70 ypg below their avg.

BOWLING GREEN by 9 over Akron - Battle tms with 1st yr HC's trying to stay out of the MAC East cellar. Falcons are 17-8 vs Zips & are on a 9-1 run but lost LTH 34-23. LY Akron led 6-0 but BG scored a td w/10 left 2Q & won 21-6 as a 6' pt AD. Akron looks to return starting QB Nelson, who after playing banged up, was susp the L/2 gms, but has been cleared to play & should be healthier. That is good news as 3 Zips combined to hit just 7-26-51 & 2 int vs NIU LW, as UA was outgained 345-145 in a 49-0 loss as a 22' pt AD. BG "only" lost to WM 49-10 being outgained 574-266. Both lost to their 2 common foes but 1 was Akron's rival Kent St, & as BG upset their rival (UT), Akron had a better show vs theirs. Against CM Akron lost 45-24 as a 2 pt AD being outgained 533-329. BG lost 38-20 to CM as a 10' pt HD being outgained 553-344. While the return of their top QB should help, the Zips 0-8 ATS TY, incl the gms he played, failing to cover by an avg 13 ppg. Look for the Falcons to keep that streak going as they have shown life at times TY.

ILLINOIS by 20 over Rutgers - These schools have alternated wins & losses in their 5 meetings with the SU winner going 5-0 ATS. The host is 0-3 SU/ATS and there have been 2 outright upsets in the series. LY IL all'd an FBS ssn low 119 rush yds and their 38-17 (-4) win snapped their 13 game B10 losing streak. RU is travelling for the lone time in a 6 week stretch & has a bye on deck following their 44-34 (+7) home upset win over Liberty. Johnny Langan was the 1st Knight QB to rush for 100+ yds s/1961 & RU only all'd 329 yds before the Flames final td drive w/28 left. IL has pulled off B2B outright upsets following their 24-6 (+9) win at Purdue, their 1st road win s/'16! The Illini had a shutout until mid 4Q, but were held to only 268 yds themselves. The Knights are on a 1-17 SU run on the road with that lone win coming here in '17. In RU's 3 prior road games this year they have been outscored 117-0! IL is 16-29 as home chalk, but RU is 2-7 as an away dog.

Cincinnati by 26 over EAST CAROLINA - Cincy is on a 7-1 SU series run & has covered 7 of the L/9. As AAC rivals the host is 4-1 SU/ATS and there has been 3 outright upsets. LY the 'Cats led 35-0 mid 2Q with just 37 yds all'd en route to their 56-6 (-19) win, the largest margin in series history. Cincy enters fresh off a bye with their lone loss vs Ohio St. The 'Cats are doing it with defense, as their #16 FBS, holding foes to 99 ypg less than their avg. The struggles continue for EC under new HC Houston as the Pirates have lost 3 straight following their 45-20 (+2) blowout vs USF. EC trailed 45-10 before adding 2 scores in the L/7:10. Cincy is 9-5 as road chalk & is 4-2 ATS off a bye, while EC is 4-9 as a home dog. There's no reason to think that a Cincy team that is still competing for the NYD bid will take the struggling Pirates lightly.

Boston College by 1 over SYRACUSE - There have been 7 outright upsets in the last 9 meetings and the visitor is 3-1 SU/ATS. LY Cuse held AJ Dillon to 56 rush yds and won 42-21 (+6). The Orange have lost 3 straight after LW's 35-17 (+10) loss at FSU LW. The Orange trailed 35-3 before adding 2 late td's in garbage time. BC was crushed LW at Clemson 56-7(+34'), allowing a ssn high 674 while putting up a ssn low 177. Against similar sked strength, Cuse is -60 ypg while BC is -33 ypg. The Orange allowed another 7 sks LW, bringing their total to 42 TY but BC has virtually no pass rush, with only 7 sks all ssn. Syracuse has allowed 178 (4.6) rush ypg and Dillon has topped 100 in 5 of his L/6. Cuse is on an 0-4 ATS run while Addazio is 12-1-1 as a reg ssn Dog and this is a dog dominated series so it only makes sense that our play is with BC.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Buffalo - Bulls have won 2 of the L/3 vs EM, but are 0-4 all-time in Ypsilanti including a 37-27 loss the LTH in '14. After making bowls LW, both enter this game 4-4 SU & ATS. UB is 1-3 SU& ATS on the road, while EM is 2-1 SU but 1-2 ATS at home. Against CM LW, the Bulls won 43-20 as a 2' pt HF despite only having a 376-345 yd edge as they benefited from 5 CM TO's (24 pts off TO). EM lost to CM 42-16 as a 5' pt AF being outgained 587-285 but 258 of CM's yds were on just 4 td plays (3 of 64+). LW EM after being tied with UT at HT, they allowed 21 straight but battled back to send gm to OT, but after settling for ts allowed a GW td to lose 37-34 as a 3 pt AD. While the Bulls may have a slight edge overall the HT has won 4 straight SU & ATS and so we look for the Eagles to bounce back after their OT loss.

NORTH CAROLINA by 3 over Virginia - Virginia is 2-0 SU/ATS and LY the 'Hoos won 31-21 (-9). We won our Underdog POW last week going against NC. The Tar Heels won 20-17 (-3), getting an int after Duke had first and goal at the NC2 with :18 left. UVA was upset LW at L'ville 28-21 (-3). UVA led 14-7 at half then allowed 21 unanswered before getting a td with :21 left. NC is +53 ypg against our #13 sked. UVA is +60 ypg against our #68 sked. The 'Hoos are playing their 2nd of B2B road gms (3rd in 4 weeks) and they've lost 3 straight on the road. UVA has our #43 pass eff D and have held their L/4 foes under 200 pass yds but QB Howell (59%, 22-5 ratio) is will be their toughest test of the ssn. NC is on a 1-5 run as chalk but UVA is on a 1-5 ATS run so we like the Heels to win a key ACC Coastal home game.

UTAH ST by 3 over Byu - Tms first met back in 1922 and BYU leads series 48-37-3 SU. Dating back to '97, BYU has been the favorite all but 1 time (won in '13 as 6-pt road dog) but are just 5-11 ATS as chalk in that time span. LY USU (+2) led 21-0 2Q and 45-13 mid 4Q in a 45-20 win. BYU is off a bye & 2 wks ago upset #14 Boise at home, while USU is off a tough 31-7 loss at Air Force where they were held to 128 yds. BYU started 3rd string QB Romney 2 wks ago, but with an extra week of rest QB Hall (concussion vs USF) could be good to go here. BYU has #77 pass eff D, which could allow USU QB Love (154 yds. 50.4%, 4-6 ratio L/4 wks) to get back on track. Utah St is a better tm at home, as they hold foes to 122 ypg under their ssn avg & avg 270 rush yds at home while BYU is all g foes to gain 31 ypg over their ssn avg on the road & they also allow 242 rush ypg on the road. USU is 12-3-1 ATS the L3Y as a HF, but HC Sitake is 10-2 ATS as an AD at BYU & we expect the Cougs to keep it close.

NOTRE DAME by 15 over Virginia Tech - The visitor is 2-0 SU/ATS. LY ND only led 17-16 at half but pulled away for an 18 pt win (-6'). The Irish struggled in the rain LW at Michigan and lost 45-14 (E). ND was held under 200 yds for the first time in Brian Kelly's tenure. QB Book struggled with the wet ball and threw for just 73 yds. VT enters fresh off a much needed bye following their 6OT win against NCar. The Hokies are -1 ypg on the ssn and -108 ypg on the road against our #113 sked. ND is +56 ypg on the ssn and +156 ypg at home against our #33 sked. The Hokies allow 216 (4.8) rush ypg and ND avg 171 (5.0) rush ypg. ND is more talented, has performed better, and faced a tougher sked so we expect the Irish to win but our lean is with the Hokies who have covered 4 straight as dogs.

Oregon by 6 over USC - UO is on a 4-2 SU/ATS series run and the SU winner is 11-0 ATS! The host is 6-3 SU/ATS & the last meeting was in '16. USC remains in control of their own destiny to reach the P12 Title game following their 35-31 (-12) win at Colorado last Friday. The Trojans trailed by double-digits on 3 occasions, but scored the GW td after a 90/12p/w/2:15 left & true frosh QB Slovis threw for 406 yds & 4 td's. The Ducks have a bye on deck & enter off an emotional back-and-forth 37-35 (-14) win vs Wazzu. There were 6 lead changes with UO hitting the GW 26 yd fg w/no time left. Ducks RB Verdell ran for a P12 high 257 yds and UO finished with a 528-446 yd edge. UO is 26-13 as road chalk, while USC is 6-9 ATS at home. We'll call for the Ducks to win by a td in what could be a P12 Title game preview.

UCLA by 7 over Colorado - As P-12 foes UCLA is 6-2 SU vs CU, but just 3-5 ATS. LY UCLA (+9) led 10-7 in the 1Q but scored 6 pts the rest of the game & lost 38-16 as QB Montez was 22-26 for 237 & WR Shenault had 12 rec for 126 yds. UCLA has the #126 pass eff D & prior to facing USC Montez had struggled (55%, 260 yds, 0-6 ratio previous 3 gms) but threw for 324 yds, 3-0 ratio vs USC. CU's defense has all'd over 440 yds in EVERY gm this ssn & are all g P-12 foes to gain 496 ypg. UCLA's OFF hit their stride once P-12 play began, as the Bruins are avg g 488 yds & 38 pts and held Stanford to 198 tltd yds 2 wks ago. CU is on a 5-9-1 ATS slide dating back to last season & are 3-7-1 ATS as an AD in P-12 play the L3Y, but UCLA HC Kelly is just 3-8 ATS at home, but did just upset #24 Ariz St in the Rose Bowl LW & are looking stronger as the ssn moves along.

KANSAS by 1 over Kansas St - The 117th Sunflower Showdown has been played every year s/1911! KSt has won 10 straight by 24 ppg and was 7-0 ATS, but has failed to cover each of the L3Y. LY's contest was the closest in 15Y as the 'Cats won 21-17 (-10). KU has a bye on deck & enters off an emotional 37-34 (+5) come-from-behind win vs Tx Tech. The Jayhawks had a 40 yd fg attempt

with :13 left blk'd, but Tx Tech opted to field the blk & during the returner attempted a pitch which was fumbled & KU recovered w/:02 left at the Raider 22. They KU hit the GW fg w/no time remaining! There's been major upset 3 straight weeks in CFB and the latest to do so was KSt in their 48-41 (+23) stunner over Oklahoma. The 'Cats led 48-23 early 4Q and held on, with the Sooners final onside kick attempt being penalized when the ball hit a player before going 10 yards. KSt is 3-11 as regular ssn chalk vs FBS foes. Since firing their OC, KU is avg 97 ypg more than their opponents allow and we'll call for the Jayhawks to finally beat their arch-rival.

LOUISIANA by 30 over Texas St - ULL is 6-0 SU/ATS in this series, covering by an avg of 15.2 pts. LA's OFF strength is their run game, as they avg 287 yds (6.9 ypc) which is #3 FBS and TXST allows 240 rush ypg (5.1 ypc) to FBS foes this ssn. ULL last played 16 days ago & are well rested while TXST played last week & were held to 227 yds & 18 pts vs an Ark St team that came in all g 531 ypg & 38 ppg and are on the road again here. TXST's OFF has only gained over 365 yds 1 gm this ssn & have only 1 gm of 110+ rush yds and as a whole the Bobcats gain 121 less ypg than what their foes allow (#130 FBS!). The ULL defense held App St to 115 yds under their ssn avg & are holding SBC foes to 43 ypg under their ssn avg. ULL HC Napier is 14-5-2 ATS here & is 7-3-2 ATS vs SBC foes, while TXST is on a 2-7-1 ATS slide dating back to last ssn.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 21 over Vanderbilt - SC is 10-0 SU with 4 straight covers vs Vandy. SC led Tenn 21-17 at half LW then was outscored 24-0 in the 2H, giving up 2 ST's td's in the process. This is a must win for bowl elig for SC who sit at 3-5 with A&M and Clemson on the horizon. The shine from Vandy's win over Mizzou prior to their bye has dimmed after the Tigers laid a 2nd straight egg LW at KY. The Commodores are -120 ypg on the ssn and -149 ypg on the road. Against an equally tough schedule, SC is -2 ypg on the ssn and +6 ypg vs FBS foes at home. Vandy has been plagued with poor QB play which led to Mo Hasan getting the start after spending time at WR during the ssn. LY SC held RB Vaughn to 3.3 ypc and we look for the Gamecocks to take out some frustrations with a 3 td win. Vandy is 4-12 as an SEC dog and on a 1-7 ATS run.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 5 over Northern Illinois - Chippewas are 8-4 vs Huskies, but LY's 24-16 loss (+14) ended a 5 gm win streak. LY NIU led 14-3 at HT & 21-3 mid 3Q. CM got within 21-16, but down 8 were int'd at NIU6 w/:17 left. Against their only common foe, Akron, CM won 45-24 as a 2 pt HF with a 533-329 yd edge. LW against a UA tm without their starting QB (susp), NIU won 49-0 as a 22' pt HD with 2 defensive td's with 345-145 yd edge. LW at Buffalo, CM turned the ball over 5 times losing 43-20 as UB scored 24 pts off TO's. NIU is not the MAC champion team they were LY as they have struggled under a new HC (3-5 SU, 5-2-1 ATS). NIU is just 1-5 in Mt Pleasant /07 (only win 38-13 in '13) & we look for CM to regroup at home here.

Marshall by 7 over Rice - Last met in '14. The home team is 5-1 SU/4-1-1 ATS. Marshall controls their own destiny in the CUSA East after beating WKU LW 26-23 (-4). The Herd led 23-7 3Q but needed a 53 yd GW fg as time expired. Rice held S Miss 79 yds below their ssn avg but put up a ssn low 139 yds themselves in their 20-6 (+10) home loss. The Owls played w/o their #1 rusher Walter and finished with just 8 rush yds. Marshall allows 30 ypg more than their foes avg (#93 in FBS). Rice holds foes 42 ypg below their avg (#44 in FBS). Marshall is 4-16 as CUSA chalk incl 2-8 when laying DD's. Rice is 0-7 this year, but 10-4 as dogs, they've faced a tougher sked (#49 vs #94) and have been competitive in all but 1 game (4 losses by 8 pts or less) so we will call for Rice to keep it close.

COLORADO ST by 8 over Unlv - Dating back to '97 CSU is 15-3 SU (10-8 ATS) and have won the L/3 gms SU/ATS. CSU is back home here after an impressive 41-31 win at Fresno (500-388 +2 TO's), while UNLV played SDSt close (20-17 loss, 335-376) and now hit the road. Against FBS foes UNLV is all g 232 rush ypg & CSU did have RB Kinsey (703 yds, 5.6 ypc) but he is susp'd indef (CS) but bkp McElroy ran for 117 yds LW. UNLV does have the #57 pass eff D, face a pass offense that is putting up 319 ypg (#11 FBS). CSU bkp QB O'Brien has stepped in nicely for inj'd QB Hill (1716, 61%, 8-3) while UNLV may go with bkp QB Oblad again (Rogers inj. CS). UNLV is 1-6 ATS slide as an AD against MW foes but CSU is 0-5 ATS as a HF in MW play the L3Y, so we don't mind a slight lean on the underdog Running Rebels.

MEMPHIS by 5 over SMU - It's homecoming at the Liberty Bowl. UM is on a 5-0 SU/ATS series run, winning by 30 ppg & covering by 22 ppg! LY the Tigers led just 7-5 at HT, but had a 16 pt lead before all g a final td in the 28-18 (-7) win. Huge AAC West implications on the line as the winner will control its own destiny in reaching the conf title game & will still be alive for the NYD bowl bid. UM has a bye on deck, while SMU is on the 2nd of B2B away games following their 34-31 (-13) win at Houston last Thurs. The Ponies were outg'd 510-385, but were +2 TO's & had 7 sks. Leading WR Roberson was on crutches after the game (CS). Our 4★ on these pages won for the 4th time in 5 wks as we went against Memphis in their 42-41 (-10) win at Tulsa LW. The Tigers scored the GW td w/4:26 left and survived a missed 29 yd fg with no time left! SMU is 8-0 SU for the 1st time s/82 & 4-0 in conf play for the 1st time s/86. The Tigers are 10-1 SU in the month of November under HC Norvell & we'll call for a close win, knocking the Ponies from the unbeaten ranks.

TCU also enters off (minor) upset following their 37-27 (+1) win vs Texas. QB Duggan threw for a car high 273 yds & the Frogs D forced Ehlinger to throw a car high 4 int's. TCU has won 3+ B12 road games 5 of the L7Y, but is still searching for their first in '19. OKSt is 5-14-2 as B12 chalk, losing outright 10 times, while TCU is 16-9 as an away dog. The Frogs are #6 FBS on defense, holding opponents to 132 ypg below their avg & we'll call for the outright upset by the slimmest of margins, making this our Underdog Play of the Week!! **FORECAST: Tcu by 1**

TEXAS A&M by 40 over Utsa - A&M won the only previous mtg in '16 23-10 (-27). The Aggies led 14-0 1Q and 41-17 4Q LW in their 49-30 (-12) win over Miss St. The Aggies only finished w/a +8 yd edge but Miss St did go 75 yds for their final td in the final minute. UTSA is fresh off a bye. The RoadRunners covered 7 of their first 11 vs P5 foes but they've lost their L4 SU & ATS by 33 ppg. UTSA is -71 ypg against our #117 sked. A&M is +64 ypg against our #29 sked. The Aggies are holding foes 57 ypg below their avg (#37 in FBS) while UTSA avg 85 ypg less than their foes allow (#118 in FBS). HC Fisher is 5-0 SU/ATS vs Non-P5 schools, winning those by 41 ppg so we will bag the heavy favorites here.

AIR FORCE by 11 over Army - Between 1997-2016 AF was 18-2 SU/15-4-1 ATS vs Army. However the L2Y Army has won SU, making it the first time they won 2 straight in the series since winning 3 in a row from 1976-78. AF is at home for the 3rd time in 4 weeks & LW destroyed Utah St 31-7 (472-128) while Army hosted SJSt and continued their slide, losing 34-29. These tms only common foe is SJSt & AF ran for 382 yds & won 41-24. After rushing for 330 comb'd yds vs WKU & GSt, Army is avg'g 302 rush yds the L2 gms. AF on the other hand is the #2 rush team in the FBS (323 ypg, 5.4 ypc) and are holding teams to 93 rush ypg (3.3) and overall hold foes to 117 ypg under their season avg (#8 FBS). The home team in this series has struggled (4-10-1 ATS) and this is a rivalry so we don't feel comfortable laying more than 2 td's.

ARIZONA by 6 over Oregon St - It's homecoming in Tucson & this is AZ's lone home game in a 5 week stretch. OSt had won 12 of 14 SU in the series, but has now lost 3 of the L4. The Beavers are 13-4-1 ATS, but have covered just once the L4Y. LY 'Cats RB Taylor set a Reser Stadium record with 284 rush yds in the 35-14 (-5) win. OSt has alternated wins & losses each of their last 6 games and enters fresh off a bye following their 21-17 (+11) outright upset at Cal. AZ has lost 3 straight following their 41-31 (+1) loss at Stanford LW. The 'Cats appear to be utilizing a 2 QB system featuring dual threat Tate and true frosh Gunnell, who is extremely accurate and they will also have a new DC here. AZ is 19-35-1 ATS. Against 3 common foes OSt is +4 ppg & +16 ypg, while AZ is -5 ppg & -9 ypg. We'll call for the Beavers to keep this game slightly closer than expected.

TENNESSEE by 9 over Uab - UT is 4-0 vs UAB all-time but they haven't met s/10. The Vols are 25-2 vs current CUSA foes (last loss in 1975 vs N Tex) but they've struggled as big chalk under HC Pruitt, failing to cover all 3 games vs Group-of-5 foes incl 2 vs CUSA foes LY (14-3 vs Char, 24-0 vs UTEP). The Vols enter off 4 straight weeks vs SEC foes incl LW then they upset S Car. UT (+4') trailed 21-17 at half, shutout the Gamecocks in the 2H and got 2 ST's td's and won 41-21. With a bowl now possible, and considering their early ssn failure vs Georgia St, there is no way the Vols overlook UAB. However, UAB is fresh off a bye and they were competitive vs A&M LY (only outgained by 27 yds). The Blazers are 9-4 as dogs and find themselves in that role for the first time TY. We never mind going with Bill Clark so we will call for UAB to keep it closer than expected.

AUBURN by 15 over Ole Miss - The visitor is 4-1 SU/5-0 ATS in this series. Auburn is 7-3 ATS. The Tigers enter off a physical loss LW at LW, 23-20 (+10'). Despite the close score, Auburn was outgained 508-287 and outFD'd 30-16. Ole Miss is fresh off a bye. The Rebels have lost 4 of 5 but did outgain A&M 405-337 in their 7 pt loss prior to the bye. Aub allows 106 (3.2) rush ypg but both Derrick Brown and Marlon Davidson were banged up LW and are ? (CS). Ole Miss avg 226 (5.1) with QB Plumlee providing a spark (three 100-yd gms). The Tigers are +72 ypg but only +12 ypg in SEC play. Ole Miss is +26 ypg and +44 ypg in SEC play, though Aub has faced the tougher sked (#4 vs #33). Aub is 9-19-1 as a HF but they've covered all 3 in that role TY. The Rebels are 4-1 ATS in conf play and we will call for Ole Miss to keep it slightly closer than expected.

NORTH TEXAS by 20 over Utep - NT has won 2 straight over UTEP but LY was only by a fg as nearly 4 td chalk. The home tm is 3-0 ATS. This is a must win for NT after getting upset LW at Charlotte 39-38 (-4). NT led 35-21 4Q. UC got the GW td with :18 left. UTEP has lost 6 straight after LW's 42-21 (+20) loss vs LA Tech. NT is +26 ypg and +124 ypg at home. UTEP is -96 ypg and -129 ypg on the road. UTEP is allowing 68% compl and they are ranked #120 in pass eff D. QB Fine has topped 375 pass yds in the L2 incl 394 and 5 td's LW. He should have another big performance against UTEP. NT has only covered 1 of their L5 at home and UTEP is 6-3 as an AD so we will call for the Miners to keep it slightly closer than expected.

TULANE by 13 over Tulsa - It's homecoming in New Orleans. Tulsa was on a 11-1 SU/ATS series run, but Tulane has won & covered each of the L2Y. The SU winner is 14-0 ATS! This is the lone home game in a 5 week stretch for Tulane and they have a bye on deck. Our FREE college plays on buttons 9 & 3 combined to go 7-1 LW (call 1-347-677-1700 everyday!) with Tulane providing 1 of the winners after their 41-38 (+4) emotional loss at Navy. The Green Wave trailed 24-0 mid 2Q, but rebounded to tie the game twice in the 4Q before all'g the GW 48 yd fg w/no time left. We've gone with or against Tulsa as a ★ rated play each of the L4W on these pages and are 4-0! LW Tulsa was a 4★ winner after nearly pulling off the outright upset over Memphis. The Hurricane had 584-498 yd & 33-21 FD edges, but missed the GW 29 yd fg w/no time left and lost 42-41 (+10). Tulane is 9-4 ATS at home and we'll call for them to become bowl eligible after beating Tulsa by just under 2 td's.

Mississippi St by 7 over ARKANSAS - Miss St is 6-1 SU/4-3 ATS vs Ark and LY the Bulldogs won 52-6 (-21') and held a 475-219 yd edge. Miss St trailed 28-7 2Q vs A&M LW. The Bulldogs were only outgained 441-433 but they did go 75 yds on their final drive and scored in gbg time. Ark was down 41-0 (+34') at halftime LW vs a Tua-less Bama. The Razorbacks were outgained 275-12 in the 1H. Ark has lost 5 straight and Miss St has lost 4 straight. Miss St is -76 ypg in SEC play while Ark is -137. HC Stockstill is 20-12 as an AF and with Rice and ODU on deck they've still got a good shot at a bowl so we will take the Blue Raiders by more than a td.

WKU by 1 over Fau - FAU is 2-0 vs WKU under HC Kiffin, winning by 19 & 14 pts. We picked up another Early Bird winner (Free on Monday's on the NorthCoast Comp Line, 1-800-654-3448, 6-1 run!) with FAU beating Old Dominion 41-3 (-13') though QB Robison was banged up and is a ?. The Owls led 24-3 at half and finished w/a 430-204 yd edge. WKU (+5') nearly pulled another upset LW at Marshall. The Toppers trailed 23-7 3Q then tied gm but MU kicked a GW 54 yd fg as time expired. WKU finished w/+25 yd & +5 FD edges but were -3 TO's. FAU is +12 ypg on the ssn and +78 ypg vs CUSA foes. WKU is +49 ypg and +59 ypg vs CUSA foes. WKU holds foes 112 ypg below their avg (#12 in FBS) while FAU avg 29 ypg more than their foes allow (#54 in FBS). HC Helton is 5-0 ATS vs CUSA foes so we will take the Toppers to win but there's no line at presstime.

FLORIDA ST by 3 over Miami, FI - Miami has won 2 straight in this series after FSU had won 7 straight. The visitor is 5-0 ATS. LY Miami was 2 td' chalk and had the largest comeback in series history after trailing 27-7 in the 2H. FSU is off a 35-17 (-10') win vs Syracuse. Alex Hornibrook got the start and threw for 196. FSU is 3-0 in games started by Hornibrook. Miami is off an outright upset over Pitt (+4'). The 'Canes were playing w/o leading rusher Du Dallas (CS). QB Perry was replaced in the 2H by former starter Williams who threw a GW td pass with :58 left. Miami was outgained 322-208 but held Pitt to 4 fg's. Over their L5, UM has rushed for just 88 (3.1). FSU is allowing 169 (3.9). The 'Canes are +85 ypg and +34 ypg vs ACC foes. FSU is -27 ypg and -18 ypg vs ACC foes but they've faced a much tougher sked (#23 vs #77). Both teams are desperate for a win and this should come down to the wire so we will give the home tm a 3 pt edge.

NEVADA by 8 over New Mexico - Series is tied 3-3-1 SU, but dating back to '11 Nev is 3-1 SU/ATS and overall the home team is 1-5-1 SU. Last wk Nev went back to QB Strong (Malik Henry not on active roster) and struggled, losing to Wyoming 31-3. NM trailed Hawaii 45-10 in 4Q last wk before coming back to cut it 14 pts late in a 45-31 loss. NM is just 2-6 SU/ATS this ssn, but their rush attack is strong (212 ypg, 5.1 ypc) led by Ahmari Davis (743 yds, 6.0 ypc, 6 TD). The F/6 gms Nev's rush D all'd 118 ypg (3.5 ypc) but the L2 gms they have all'd 251 ypg (5.7 ypc). Nev can get their OFF back on track (661 yds, 13 pts L2 wks) vs a NM defense all'g 508 ypg incl 347 pass ypg (#127 pass eff D). Nev is 10-6 ATS under Norvell at home incl 6-3 ATS vs MW foes, while NM is 6-14 ATS in MW play the L3Y & NM is on the road for the 4th time in the last 6 weeks.

Utah by 6 over WASHINGTON - Rematch of LY's P-12 title game. Utah is just 1-2 SU vs UW, with the lone win coming in '15 (34-23). UW has won the L4 straight up, but only by an avg of 8 points. UW comes in off a bye while Utah held Cal to 83 total yds in a 35-0 blowout. The L3 games Utah is holding foes to 145 ypg & 3 ppg. UW does have a solid rush attack (172 ypg, 4.7 ypc) but face a Utah DEF that is all'g just 56 rush ypg (#1 FBS). Utah's DEF is also holding P-12 foes to 205 ypg under their ssn avg. UW QB Eason is avg'g just 216 pass yds in P-12 play & faces the #4 pass eff D here, but vs Oregon they did gain 121 more yds than the Ducks came in allowing & only lost by 4 pts. Utah is 22-11 ATS the L4Y against P-12 teams while UW is 1-4 ATS as a HD under HC Petersen but barely lost in this role 2 wks ago vs Oregon. UW is off a bye & will have the crowd edge & series edge on their side, but we'll lean with the stronger defense in this game.

Boise St by 20 over SAN JOSE ST - Going back to 2001 Boise is 12-0 SU / 8-4 ATS vs SJSt. Last meeting was 2016 when Boise (-30) never trailed in a 45-31 win. Boise is off a bye and QB Bachmeier (inj'd vs Hawaii) is still ? for this game, but backup QB Cord has thrown for 480 yds & an 8-2 ratio this ssn. SJSt QB Love is having a stellar season, putting up 2,355 yds (59%, 15-3) but Bosie's #23 pass eff D is the best secondary Love has faced all ssn. The lone MW foe they have in common this ssn is AF, and Boise won 30-19 at home (held AF to 242 rush yds) while SJSt lost 41-24 & gave up 382 rush yds. Boise's rush attack is avg'g 168 yds this ssn, but face a SJSt run D that is giving up 279 ypg the L5 gms. Boise is 6-2 ATS the L3Y as an AF in MW play while SJSt is just 1-4 ATS off a straight up win under HC Brennan.

HAWAII' by 3 over Fresno ST - Fresno is 8-2 SU (6-3-1 ATS) against UH dating back to 2009. Fresno is off a 41-31 loss to CSU, where they all'd 322 pass yds while Hawaii cashed in a 4★ Late Phone Winner for us last week, winning 45-31 (led 45-10 mid 4Q) at NMex. UH has the #3 pass attack, as they put up 355 ypg but Fresno counters with the #40 pass eff D. Fresno's offense is avg'g 382 ypg in MW play, but can get their unit going against a Hawaii defense that is all'g 513 ypg the L3 gms. Both teams played Air Force & both lost by over 2 TD's as UH all'd 353 rush yds & Fresno all'd 340 rush yds. UH is just 4-10 ATS as a HF under Rolovich, while Fresno is 6-1 ATS as an AF under Tedford. On paper these teams are pretty even, and we'll call for Hawaii' to get the win, but this should be a close gm.

TUESDAY NOVEMBER 5TH

Kent St at TOLEDO - Both are still in their divisional races & neither can afford a loss. Kent St has not won in the Glass Bowl s/77, losing 11 straight incl LTH ('15) 38-7. Toledo has won 4 straight wins by 21 ypg. However while both held their only common for BG to 20 pts, UT only scored 7 & was outgained 425-392 while Kent St scored 62 & had a 750-360 yd edge. Can Kent St pull off another Flashy win here or will the Rockets keep streaking against KS.

Ball St at WESTERN MICHIGAN - Broncos have won 6 of 19 mtgs, but LY's Ball St won 42-41 in OT ending a 4 gm series losing streak. 4★ OAKLAND over Detroit - For the first time in 49 days, the Raiders are FINALLY back inside of the "Black Hole" as they went 6 weeks between home matchups (4 true AG's, trip to London & bye week). The do however return to the Bay Area on a 2-game losing skid as the Packers and Texans (3 pt loss) picked up victories. The Lions ended their own 2-game losing skid LW at home against the Giants as QB Stafford threw for 342 yds & 3 TD's in the 5 pt win. In the most recent meeting between these 2 back in '15, DET (-1) held 22-13 FD & 375-216 yd edges in the 18-13 home victory. While the Lions have covered 5 of their past 6 against the AFC coming in, they do have a critical DIV AG against CHI on deck. With 3 consec HG's in front of a re-charged Raider fanbase, OAK gets the victory in this one. **FORECAST: OAKLAND by 10**

3★ Green Bay over LA CHARGERS - This marks the 3rd consec non-conf matchup for GB who delivered a 7 pt victory LW in Arrowhead against a KC squad that was without QB Mahomes (GB QB Rodgers 305 yds & 3 TD's). The Chargers were also in non-conf action a wk ago in Soldier Field against the Bears who once again missed a FG on the final play allowing LA to get the 1 pt victory (CHI 25-10 FD & 388-231 yd edges). In their most recent meeting back in '15, GB earned a 27-20 win (-10) over the Chargers despite large FD (32-17) & yard (548-370) deficit. With LAC going just 6-12 ATS as a HD coming in and "Cheesehead Nation" expected to "pack" Dignity Health Sports Park as most visiting teams have done against LA, we'll call for GB to improve upon their already outstanding 8-1 ATS mark against the AFC. **FORECAST: Green Bay by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Tampa Bay (+) over SEATTLE - Following a 7 pt victory LW in ATL (led 24-0 at HT) where they had massive FD (30-18) & yd (512-322) deficits (+3 TO's), the Seahawks return to the Pacific NW where they've surprisingly struggled TY with an 0-3-1 ATS mark including outright upsets against the Saints and Ravens. The Bucs meanwhile returned from their bye LW in Nashville with their own TO issues (2 int & 2 fmbals by QB Winston in a 4 pt loss). In their most recent matchup back in '16, the Bucs won for a 4th time in 5 tries by holding SEA to just 245 yds in the 14-5 upset home victory (+5). While we'll go ahead and call for the Seahawks to win this time around, their previously mentioned home struggles and 4-11-2 ATS mark as a HF has us calling for TB to stay within the line. **FORECAST: SEATTLE by 1**

OTHER PLAYS

San Francisco at ARIZONA - Thursday - First of 2 matchups in a 3-wk span between the 49ers and Cardinals. For ARZ, this marks their only HG in a 5-wk period as they're fresh off of trips to NYG & NO (held to just 10 FD's & 237 yds in a 31-9 loss) with a journey to TB and the previously mentioned visit to the Bay Area on deck. The 49ers remained undefeated on the '19 campaign a week ago at home against CAR as they reached the 50+ pt mark for the 1st time in 17 years! In their meetings of a year ago, a favored SF squad came up short on both occasions to extend their series losing streak against the Cardinals to 8 in a row (4-4 ATS, ARZ 11 pt avg MOV). While it wouldn't surprise us to see SF finally snap their losing skid against the Cardinals this time around, keep in mind that they have a key home matchup on deck against DIV rival SEA on MNF. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

† Jacksonville by 1 over Houston - London. Following a relatively easy 14 pt win a week ago in JAX where they finished with 20-14 FD & 389-213 yd edges, the Jaguars now head to their home away from home in London where they play for a 7th consecutive season (3-3 SU & ATS). The Texans meanwhile are headed across the pond for the very first time in franchise history following a 3 pt win LW at home against the Raiders (29-15 FD edge, JJ Watt OFY w/inj). In their Wk 2 contest in HOU earlier TY, the Jaguars got a 4 yd TD pass with :30 left to cut their deficit to 13-12. Instead of going for the PAT and eventual OT, JAX's 2 pt run att was stopped short allowing the Texans to narrowly prevail despite being 7 pt chalk. In their 2 matchups of a year ago, HOU held JAX to a total of 10 pts in their 3rd series sweep in the past 4 years. While the Texans are 8-1-1 ATS prior to their bye week, their inexperience in traveling here and JAX's near upset earlier TY has us siding with the dog in this one.

BUFFALO by 7 over Washington - Rematch of SB XXVI, a game in which WAS (-7) captured a 37-24 victory for their 3rd and most recent Lombardi Trophy. Unfortunately, this Redskins squad is well on their way to the worst record in the NFC this time around following their 8th loss in 9 tries last Thur against the Vikings where QB Keenum was lost in the 2H w/a concussion (rookie QB Haskins 3-5-33-0-1 in relief). The Bills meanwhile fell to the Redskins' DIV rival PHI a week ago in BUF as they were held to just 13 FD's & 253 yds in the 18 pt defeat. In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Bills went into D.C. as 2 pt road chalk and fell 35-25 as WAS jumped out to a 21-0 HT lead. With the Redskins having extra rest coming in and BUF struggling as a big home favorite just a few weeks back against MIA, we're cutting off our lean at a TD in this one.

CAROLINA by 1 over Tennessee - The Panthers saw their 4-gm winning streak snapped in embarrassing fashion at SF as the 49ers put up 51 pts in the 38 pt victory. The Titans meanwhile held on late against the Bucs LW at home despite 23-17 FD & 389-246 yd deficits (+3 TO's). In the most recent meeting back in '15, the Panthers went into Nashville as 4 pt chalk and came away with a 27-10 victory (24-11 FD & 303-242 yd edges) en route to a 15-1 regular season. With the Titans covering 4 of their past 5 when listed as a NDIV AD and the Panthers looking suspect for the 1st time with QB Allen under center, we'll be leaning with the visitor here.

PHILADELPHIA by 7 over Chicago - Rematch of LY's memorable WC matchup in Soldier Field where the Bears (-6) suffered the infamous "Double Doink" missed 43-yd FG by K Parkey w/0:05 left in the 16-15 defeat. After a 3-game road trip that saw the Eagles knocked off by the Vikings & Cowboys and later claiming a big 18 pt road win at BUF, they finally return home for a matchup against the Bears prior to their Wk 10 bye week. The Bears meanwhile saw their losing skid extend to 3 in a row LW against the Chargers despite holding LA to just 11 FD's & 195 yds (missed GW 41 yd FG on final play). With the Eagles covering 5 of their L/6 prior to a bye week and CHI's offense clearly sputtering at the moment, we'll go ahead and give the home squad the lean here as they look to stay within reach of NFC East-leading DAL.

MINNESOTA at KANSAS CITY - Following a 10 pt home victory over the Redskins last Thur where they finished w/a 434-216 yd edge, the Vikings head to Arrowhead with extra rest to take on a Chiefs squad that fell at home once again vs the Packers despite a decent outing from bkp QB Moore (24-36-267-2-0). In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Vikings (-3) jumped out to a 13-0 lead after 3Q's before KC got a TD & FG in the final frame to make things interesting late (16-10 MIN win). While the Vikings are on an impressive 16-5 ATS run against the AFC coming in, the status of Chiefs MVP QB Mahomes is up in the air as of presstime. We're going to have to wait until closer to kickoff to make a solid decision on which way to lean in this one.

NY Jets by 3 over MIAMI - Only HG in a 4-wk span for the Dolphins who return to action on short rest following a MNF matchup against the Steelers. The Jets meanwhile have now dropped B2B contests after their surprising upset of the Cowboys back in Wk 6 as the Jaguars held them to

just 213 yds in their 14 pt win. In their 2 matchups of a year ago, the Dolphins held the Jets to a total of 18 pts in the series sweep. While MIA is on just a 2-7 ATS run as of presstime, it's worth mentioning that the Jets have now failed to cover 7 of their L/9 inside of the AFC East.

PITTSBURGH by 3 over Indianapolis - Following a come-from-behind 2 pt home win over the Broncos where they connected on a GW 51 yd FG w/:22 left, the Colts head to PIT riding a 3-game winning streak. The Steelers meanwhile are back at home on short rest after a MNF tilt against the Dolphins. In their most recent meeting back in '17, the Steelers went into IND as a 10 pt favorite against a very banged-up Colts squad and picked up a narrow 20-17 victory (PIT won L/5 overall by 16 ppg). While the Colts are the favorite this time around and have covered 8 of their past 11 overall, not only has PIT covered 4 in a row as of presstime, but they've also gone 12-4-1 ATS when listed as a HD.

Cleveland by 3 over DENVER - The Browns and Broncos had some memorable AFC Championship matchups ("The Drive" & "The Fumble") in the late '80's with DEN earning 3 Super Bowl berths in the process. In fact, prior to CLE's 17-16 upset (+2) at the end of LY over DEN, the Broncos had collected 11 consec wins with a 13 pt avg MOV. Both teams do enter this matchup following road losses as the Browns had 3 consec TO's in the 1H of a 27-13 defeat against the Patriots while the Broncos fell just short once again with IND getting the GW 51 yd FG w/:22 remaining. With DEN having failed to cover 9 of their past 12 overall coming in and CLE's schedule starting to lighten up as they enter the 2H of the year, we'll go ahead and call for the visitor to claim a 2nd consec victory in as many years inside of "Mile High."

New England at BALTIMORE - SNF - Following a 14 pt home victory against the Browns where HC Belichick earned his 300th career win, the Patriots head to BAL in search of their 11th win in 14 tries against a well-rested Ravens squad who earned a 30-16 (+3) upset win against the Seahawks in the Pacific NW before their bye week. Prior to suffering a beatdown on the road LY against the Titans, the Patriots had won 9 in a row before a bye while going 8-1 ATS (39-17 avg win). The Ravens meanwhile also have an impressive mark involving a bye as they've gone 13-4 ATS following their week off. With NE looking to remain unbeaten on the season, it will be interesting to see if they can add on to an already impressive 11-5 ATS mark as a NDIV AF. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Dallas at NY GIANTS - MNF - It's been a rough stretch for the Giants over the past month as the Lions handed them their 4th consec loss LW in Ford Field despite a 322 yd, 4 TD day from QB Jones. The Cowboys meanwhile return from their bye week having covered 13 of their past 15 inside of the NFC East. In their Wk 1 matchup TY, DAL got a 405 yd, 4 TD effort from QB Prescott in the easy 35-17 victory (-7). While the Cowboys are 14-7-1 ATS as an AF, they do have an important HG against the Vikings on the horizon which may cause them to look ahead.
