4★ Alabama over AUBURN - Nick Saban is 8-4 in the Iron Bowl but 3 of their losses have come at Jordan-Hare. LY Bama got revenge for 2017 loss with 52-21 (-24*) win, though they did only lead 17-14 at half. Both tms enter fresh off their annual pre Iron-Bowl prep vs an FCS foe. Mac Jones takes over for inj'd QB Tagovaila. Jones is hitting 71% w/a 7-1 ratio. Aub is +121 ypg and +54 ypg in SEC play. The Tigers avg 427 ypg but they've been held under 300 yds on 3 occasions and were shutout vs UGA for over 3Q 2 wks ago. Bama has held foes 77 ypg below their avg and we think the defense will step up in the absence of their star QB. We think there will be a strong overreaction to Tua's inj and Jones is still throwing to one of the best WR units in the country. Bama is 12-6 as SEC away chalk and we call for the Tide step up and win by double-digits. **FORECAST: Alabama by 13**

3★ Uab (+) over NORTH TEXAS - UAB has covered all 3 meetings vs NT incl LY when they beat the Mean Green 29-21 (-1*). A win clinches UAB's 2nd consec CUSA West Title. QB Johnston was supposed to return LW vs LT (knee inj) but it was Dylan Hopkins who again got the start. UAB (-6) led 20-7 4Q and gave up a td w/8:07 left. NT enters off B2B losses and won't be bowing this year. The Mean Green got Mason Fine back but still only put up 238 yds and lost to Rice 20-14 (-6*). Against 5 common foes, UAB is 4-1 SU/3-1-1 ATS, +6 ppg & +89 ypg. NT is 2-3 SU/ATS, +2 ppg & -14 ypg. NT is 15-2 SU at home the L3Y and +139 ypg at home TY but UAB has the motivation edge, a huge defensive edge and is the underdog to a team that just lost to Rice. QB Johnston could return to help the cause but regardless we think UAB wins by a td. **FORECAST: Uab by 7**

3★ Navy over HOUSTON - It's Sr day in Houston. As AAC rivals UH is 3-1 SU/ATS & the host is 3-1 SU/ATS. LY the Cougars trailed by DD's 2Q, but scored 35 unanswered & won 49-36 (-12). LW Navy responded from their 1st loss in 5 games with a 35-28 (+3) win vs SMU. The Middies finished w/28-15 FD & 540-344 yd edges, but all'd a 100 yd KR td & a 42 yd td drive. The Cougars snapped their 3 gm losing streak LW with a misleading 24-14 (+3) win at Tulsa. UH was held to 12 FD's & out'd 380-231, but benefited from IR & KOR td's. UH defended the option mid Sept at Tulane and all'd 325 (6.5) rush. The misleading final scores for each team gives us better value this week. Navy is on a 10-3 overall ATS run & we'll call for the Middies to win by DD's. **FORECAST: Navy by 13**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Ohio St over MICHIGAN - OSt has won 'The Game' 14 of the L15Y including 7 straight by 12 ppg, but UM has covered 4 of the L6 & the host is on a 7-4 ATS run. It's Sr day in Ann Arbor, but the Wolves haven't beaten the Buckeyes w/o an interim HC in their home finale s/03! UM is ply'g w/revenge after having their playoff hopes shattered while all g the most pts ever in regulation in their 62-39 (-4) blowout loss LY. The Wolves are playing their best ball of the ssn & enter on a 4 gm win streak following their 39-14 (-9) route over Indy, finishing w/453-321 yd edges. OSt enters off a misleading 28-17 (-19) win vs Penn St as the Buckeyes finished w/27-15 FD & 417-227 yd edges. OSt QB Fields fumbled while running into the EZ for a td & the Bucks all'd 12 & 11 yd scoring 'drives' following TO's. Both tms are fresh off a bye. FSU has won 52B gms since firing Willie Taggart. Interim HC Odell Haggins is 4-0 SU & 3-0 ATS vs FBS foes. The 'Noles are -16 ypg on the season while UF is +113. The Gators are +257 ypg at home while FSU is -108 ypg on the road. James Blackman has a 16-7 ratio and RB Akersis well rested after sitting out vs Alabama St prior to the bye. The stats all point to Florida, but we expect a rejuvenated Florida St team to give a maximum effort as a large underdog. **FORECAST: FLORIDA by 10**

Ole Miss at MISSISSIPPI ST - The visitor has won 4 straight in the Egg Bowl and there has been 4 upsets in the L6 meetings. LY the revenge minded Bulldogs led 21-3 and had a 420-189 yd edge at half then added 2 2H td's. Ole Miss enters fresh off a bye. The Rebels have topped 600 yds in B2B gms incl 614 vs LSU when QB Plumlee rushed for 212. The Rebels avg 261 (5.6) rush ypg. Miss St won easily over an FCS foe LW and needs to win this to be bowl eligible. The Bulldogs are -7x ypg and -38 ypg vs SEC foes. Against 5 SEC West foes, UM is 1-4 SU/2-3 ATS, -9.6 ppg & -49.6 ypg. MSU is 1-4 SU/ATS, -15.2 ppg & -42 ypg. The Rebels have an explosive offense and have covered 3 straight as an AD but MSU has the edge on defense and is 7-2 ATS as a HF. **FRIDAY NOVEMBER 29TH**

BUFFALO by 35 over Bowling Green - BG is 11-5 in series incl 6-2 in Buffalo but UB has won L/2 SU & ATS. LY Bulls needing a win to make the MAC Championship, led 34-7 at HT winning 44-14 (-14*) pt. LTH BG never led the 53 yd line. LW BG (+20) led Ohio 14-7 but despite a FG w/02 trailed 38-24 at HT & were outscored 28-0 in 2H. LW we won our Wed Night Marquee on the Over 54 in the UB/UT gm. We knew the Bulls after a 4Q collapse vs Kent St would not hold back & they put up 49 themselves in a 19 pt win (-8*). BG is 3-8 SU & ATS incl 0-5 SU & ATS on the road, all as dog, losing by avg 45 ppg (closest was 39 vs MU). While UB is bowl eligible, they didn't make a bowl in '17 at 6-6, so will not rest here. With the KS gm still fresh in their memory, they will not take their foot off the gas.

Virginia Tech by 3 over VIRGINIA - VT has held the Commonwealth Cup for 5,476 days, winning the L15 mtgs vs rival UVA. LY VT pulled out a fortunate 34-31 (+4) win in OT. LW we honored VT DC Bud Foster in his last home game by using 'Under 45' for our Totals GOY! Played on a sloppy field, VT recorded their 2nd consecutive shutout and held Pitt to 177 yd and 8 FD's in their 28-0 (-3*) win! UVA avoided a letdown by beating Liberty 55-27 (-16*). VT has held their L3 foes 193 ypg below their avg. UVA is holding foes 52 ypg below their avg (#36 in FBS). VT is 6-0 when QB Hooker starts, and he comes in w/a 10-0 ratio. UVA has a banged up secondary but did get 2 int's against Lib's QB Calvert who hadn't thrown an int since week 2. This game decides the ACC Coastal and the winner is likely to get a spot in the Orange Bowl. VT has covered 5 straight so the Hokies are our pick.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 10 over Toledo - UT has won 9 straight over CM incl 4 str here. LY CM trailed 44-0 before a 53 yd FR td's w/3:58 left but that CM team finished 1-11. TY CM is 7-4, off a big come from behind 45-44 win over Ball St & are in the MAC West race. If WM wins on Tues, CM can still share the MAC West crown & if WM loses, CM would be MAC West Champ with a win. LW Toledo was in the thick of the MAC West race, with a win over WM giving them the edge. They ran into a Buffalo team off a 4Q collapse the wk prior. It was 14-14 early 2Q but UT (+8*) trailed 28-20 at HT & 49-23 before scoring a td w/18 left to only lose by 19. While UT has dropped 6 straight ATS (2 SU wins by com 5 pt), CM is 8-1 ATS their L9 (only loss vs UB). We look for CM to break their losing streak to the Rockets, especially if WM lost.

UCF by 15 over UF - It's Sr day in Orlando & UCF is 9-4 SU/8-4-1 ATS run in home finales. The War on I-4 Trophy is at stake & these campuses are only 96 miles apart. As AAC rivals the Knights are 4-2 SU/2-4 ATS and the host is 1-5 ATS. LY UCF ran for a ssn high 391 yds and won 38-10 (-14). The Knights enter having won 4 of 5 following their 34-31 (-6) win at Tulane. UCF led by over 2 td's mid 4Q before all'g two 75 yd td drives & needed to recover an onsite w/26 left to preserve the win. USF is staying home for the holidays for the 1st time s/14 after getting blown out 49-10 (+14*) vs Memphis. RB Cronkrite DNP (CS) & the Bulls were held to just 5 FD's & 170 yds! USF is 8-1 as a DD away dog. On paper this game is a mismatch, but we think the Bulls, who had 438 yds 2 wks ago vs Cincy, will show some pride and in a rivalry game keep this contest closer than expected.

TEXAS by 8 over Texas Tech - It's Sr day in Austin, but TX is on a 2-7 SU/ATS run in home finales. The 'Horns have won the Chancellor's Spurs Trophy 16 of the L20Y & has covered 7 of the L9, however the visitor is on a 5-0 SU/ATS run and TT has pulled the outright upset their L/2 games here. The L/4 mtgs have been 1 possession gms & LY TX scored the GW td w/21 left in the 41-34 (-1*) victory. The 'Horns enter having lost 3 of 4 following their 24-10 (+5) loss at Baylor. In the 2H and in BU territory, TX was SOD twice and threw an int, as both tms finished w/391 tll yds. TT is staying home for the holidays in B2B ssn's for the 1st time since the early 90's following their 30-27 (-2*) loss vs Kansas St. The Raiders had a 512-372 yd edge, but all'd a KOR td & was int'd in the EZ mid 4Q. TX is 4-12 as home chalk, while TT is 12-6 as an away dog. Recent series history suggest a closer game & the Raiders have lost 4 gms TY by 1 pss so we'll call for another game that finishes closer than expected.

Kent St by 1 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Flashes are 4-1 s/06 vs Eagles incl a 41-14 win LTH (-12). LY EM trailed 10-0, but led 28-0 early 3Q & won 28-20. EM is off their first win over NIU s/07. EM won 45-17 (+5) but only had 24-21 fd & 428-337 yd edges as they had 17 pts off 3 NIU TO's in 2H. KS came up 2 pt short vs UT (2 pt conv NG) & at 3-6 trailed UB 27-6 w/8:00 left. They shocked UB with 24 unanswered kicking the GW fg as time expired. LW as a 3' pt UB, they beat Ball St 41-38 hitting the GW fg w/19 left & have covered 3 straight. New HC Lewis, has them believing in themselves. A win here & they are bowl eligible for the 1st time s/12 (won MAC East). EM is just 4-10 ATS as a HF under HC Creighton incl 0-3 TY losing both MAC gms as a HF outright. Against 4 common MAC foes KS is 3-1 SU & 4-0 ATS while EM is just 1-3 SU & 2-2 ATS. EM has opened as a 5 pt HF, so we will follow all the trends & take Kent St & the points.

LY MU (-17) trailed 21-7 w/4:45 left 2Q but it was 21-21 HT & MU won 42-21. Miami wrapped up the MAC East prior to LW's game vs Akron, who came in 0-10 SU & ATS. Iowa by 6 over NEBRASKA - It's Sr day in Lincoln & NU has won 23 of their L/31 home finales & is 19-10 SU on Black Friday s/90. Iowa has won the Heroes Trophy 5 of the L6Y, is on a 5-2 ATS series run & the visitor has covered 5 of the L/6 mtgs. LY the Huskers came back from 15 down to tie the game with 3:22 left before all'g the GW 41 yd fg w/no time left & lost 31-28 (-8*). The Hawkeyes enter having won 4 of 5 & have held B2B foes to their ssn low in pts following their 19-10 (-15) win vs IL. QB Stanley threw for a ssn high 308 yds. NU kept their bowl hopes alive & snapped their 4 gm losing streak by dominating MD 54-7 (-6*). The Huskers had 31-9 FD & 531-206 yd edges, their str's were out by the 3Q, & they had a shutout until late 4Q. NU is 1-7 as a home dog & is on a 2-9 overall ATS run, while Iowa is 17-3-1 as road chalk. The Huskers rely on their run game & the Hawkeyes only allow 115 (3.7) rush ypg so despite a bowl on the line for the Huskers, we'll call for the visitor to cover for the 6th time in the L7Y.

Missouri by 10 over ARKANSAS - This game is being played in Little Rock. MO is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in the last 3 meetings. The home tm is 5-0 ATS in SEC mtgs. LY MO led 28-0 at half w/a 230-41 yd edge and went on to win 38-0 (-23). Ark showed signs of life LW, only trailing 7-6 2Q at LSU. The Hogs (+42) then allowed 49 straight before getting a backdoor cover with 2 ppg time td's. MO enters off a deceiving 4 pt loss vs Tenn. The Tigers (-4) were outgained 526-280 & out FD'd 26-16. MO is -122 ypg, -12 ppg and 0-5 SU/ATS in their L/5. Ark has lost 8 straight and has been outgained by 192 ypg in SEC play. MO needs 1 win to get bowl elig but their appeal for their bowl ban is still pending. Clearly it's hard to back either team right now. MO is 0-4 ATS on the road, suffering 3 losses as DD chalk so we have to think Arkansas keeps it closer than expected.

MEMPHIS by 13 over Cincinnati - It's Sr day in Memphis & the Tigers have won 6 of their L/7 home finales including 5 straight. UM has won 3 in a row SU in the series, but Cincy has covered 7 of the L/9 and the visitor is on a 4-0 ATS run. The last mtg was in '16. The Tigers enter off a 49-10 (-14*) blowout at USF, finishing w/31-5 FD & 560-170 yd edges! The 'Cats enter on a 9 gm winning streak following their 15-13 (-10) win vs Temple. Cincy has been out'd 6 of their L7 gms including 310-210 LW as QB Ridder is dealing with a sore shoulder & is completing just 42% while throwing for a total of 140 yds the L2W. UM is 12-1 ATS hosting AAC foes & is on a 20-6 overall ATS run. The winner remains the favorite to grab the coveted G5 NYD bowl bid & the Tigers must also win to secure an AAC Title berth. We feel that Cincy's luck will run out this week as Memphis is ply'g its best ball of the ssn.

Arkansas St by 17 over SOUTH ALABAMA - Ark St is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS vs SAAla & home team has won 4 of the L/5 mtgs ATS. LTH in '17 Ark St (-10) entered 4-0 SU/ATS in SBC play, but never led in a 24-19 loss (365-340, -5 TO's). Ark St is off a 38-33 win over GS while SAAla fell 28-15 at GSt. Against 6 common SBC foes Ark St is 4-2 SU/ATS & -18 ypg while SAAla is 0-6 SU, but 4-2 ATS & are -67 ypg. Ark St's pass attack led by QB Hatcher (70%, 21-9) and WR Bayless who leads the FBS in yds (1375) and TD's (15) that will face a SAAla pass eff D ranked #116. Ark St has dealt with several inj's on DEF & allows SBC foes to gain 59 ypg over their ssn avg, but SAAla's SBC OFF is gaining 106 ypg under what their opp's come in allowing. But SAAla did put up 467 yds vs ULL 2 wks ago. Ark St is 10-6 ATS the L5Y as away chalk in SBC play & win by over 2 TD's led by their strong pass attack.

TCU by 10 over West Virginia - It's Sr day in Fort Worth, but TCU has won just 4 of their L/7 home finales. WV is on a 5-1 ATS run in the series, but the host has covered 4 of 5. LY the Frogs lost 47-10 (+13*), their most lopsided loss under HC Patterson. TCU enters having lost 3 of 4 & remained 1 win shy of becoming bowl elig after their misleading 28-24 (+18) loss at Oklahoma. The Frogs were outFD'd 30-11 & out'd 511-204, but benefitted from a 98 yd IR td & rec'd a fmbt at their own 10 yd line. WV has lost 6 of 7 & will be home for the holidays for the 1st time s/13 following their 20-13 (+5) loss vs OKSt. In his 2nd start QB Doege threw for 307 yds & the Mountaineers did finish w/a 333-285 yd edge but were twice forced to fg's from inside the 5 yd line. TCU is 3-11 as home chalk, while WV is 6-3 as an away dog & is 10-5 ATS on the B12 road. The Mountaineers have shown no quit under new HC Brown and while we'll call for TCU to get the win, we do feel that WV is playing well enough to keep this game closer than expected.

Boise St by 10 over COLORADO ST - Boise has dominated series 8-0 SU/6-2 ATS as MW foes. Road team is 6-2 ATS in this series. LTH Boise (-6) trailed CSU 52-38 with 3:02 left 4Q but scored 2 TD's (recov'd onsite kick) to send it to OT & Boise won it there 59-52. Boise clinched the Mountain Div LW with a 56-21 win over USU despite not having QB Bachmeier & CSU saw their bowl hopes vanish with a 17-7 loss at WY. Boise avg's 487 ypg & 224 rush ypg on the road this ssn & face a CSU run D that has all'd 194 rush ypg the L/5 gms. CSU's counters w/ the #13 pass OFF (307 ypg) led by QB O'Brien (61%, 11-5) and WR Jackson (1035, 7 TD) but face a Boise pass eff D ranked #37. Against 5 common MW foes Boise is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS and are +90 ypg & +21 ppg while CSU is 2-3 SU/3-2 ATS and are +25 ypg & -1 ppg. Boise is 12-6 ATS the L5Y as an AF in MW play, but with a trip to the MW title game locked up, Boise could rest players for that gm.

WASHINGTON by 13 over Washington St - It's Sr day in Seattle. UW is on a 9-1 SU/8-2 ATS run in the Apple Cup including 6 straight wins by 22 ppg & 5 straight covers by 19 ppg! LY in windy & snowy conditions the Huskies finished w/a 487-237 yd edge & won 28-15 (+2*). UW enters having lost 3 of 4 following their lackluster 20-14 (-14*) loss at Colorado. The Huskies were out'd 430-238. Wazzu became bowl elig for a 5th straight ssn following their emotional 54-53 (-10) win vs Oregon St. The Cougars trailed by DD's but scored 2 td's in the L/2:10 including the GW w/02 left! QB Gordon threw for 606 yds & 6 td's now is P12 single ssn record holder w/45 td passes & 4,920 pass yds! The Huskies have our #18 pass eff D and should be able to slow down Gordon. UW is 12-2 ATS in weekday games & we'll side with series history and call for UW to win by 2 td's.

Appalachian St by 17 over TROY - 5th mtg as SBC foes (App St 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS). LW Troy fell to ULL 53-3 (359-598) while App St had little trouble w/ TXSt 35-13. Troy comes in w/ the #12 ranked pass OFF (312 ypg) led by QB Barker who is #6 in the FBS w/ 3,347 yds (66%, 30-9 ratio). But App counters w/ the #43 ranked pass eff D. App is a run-first team led by RB Evans (1168, 5.7, 14 TD) and faces a Troy run D that just all'd ULL to run for 254 yds. App QB Thomas is an effective passer (62%, 20-5 ratio) and faces a Troy pass eff D rated #123. App is holding SBC foes to 140 ypg under their ssn avg while Troy is all'g SBC foes to gain 76 ypg above their ssn avg. Against 6 common SBC foes App is 5-1 SU & +166 ypg while Troy is 3-3 SU & +34 ypg. App is 11-6 as SBC road chalk while Troy is 1-3 ATS the L8Y as a HD.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 30TH

Georgia by 31 over GEORGIA TECH - UGA is 15-3 SU/12-5-1 ATS and have won 9 straight vs GT in Atlanta. LY we won our Totals GOY on this game, going Over 59 with UGA winning 45-21 (-17). The Dawgs were held under 300 yds for the 3rd time in 5 weeks LW but still beat A&M 19-13 (-13). UGA held A&M to -1 rush yds. GT gets extra rest after beating NCSt 28-26 (-2) on Thurs. The Jackets led 21-3 at half but did get outgained by 62 yds. UGA is +146 ypg and their defense holds foes 140 ypg below their avg (#4 in FBS). GT avg 157 rush ypg (4.2) and RB Mason had 141 LW. UGA allows 69 (2.5) rush ypg and just 39 (1.4) in their L/4. The Dawgs offensive struggles will prevent them from running it up too much on the Jackets and this is by far the largest line in at least 40 years of 'Clean Old Fashioned Hate', but we still think UGA clears the 4 td opening line.

TEMPLE by 30 over UConn - It's Sr day in Philadelphia & TU has won 6 of the L/8 & covered 11 of the L/13 mtgs, but the host is on a 1-6 SU/ATS run. LY the Owls won in a blowout 57-7 (-31) setting a schl rec for their largest MOV. TU enters off an emotional 15-13 (+10) loss at Cincy. The Owls held the 'Cats to a ssn low 210 yds & WR Blue had his 3rd straight gm of 10+ rec's & 100+ yds, but TU had a PAT blk'd & ret'd for 2, which resulted in the final MOV. UConn enters having lost 9 of 10 including 3 straight, but showed no quit in their 31-24 (+14) loss vs EC. The Huskies trailed by DD's entering the 4Q, but tied the gm before all'g the GW td w/3:28 left. True frosh QB Zergiotis threw for a car high 418 yds, but UConn was outFD'd 32-20. UConn is 13-27 as an away dog & is on a 27-54 overall ATS run, while TU is 10-5 as home chalk & is on a 42-21 overall ATS run. The Owls have beaten 3 FBS foes by DD's TY while the Huskies have lost by 35+ five times and we'll call for TU to score another blowout in the series.

Tulsa by 6 over EAST CAROLINA - It's Sr day in Greenville & EC hasn't won 3 straight home finales s/2011-13. The Pirates had their 6 gm series win streak snapped in the last mtg ('16) and TU is on a 3-0 ATS series run. The host is 4-1 SU/ATS. The Hurricane can lose 6 of 7 following their misleading 24-14 (-3) loss vs Houston. TU had 18-12 FD & 380-231 yd edges, but was -3 TO's & all'd IR & KOR td's. EC snapped a 5 gm losing streak after surviving to win 31-24 (-14) at UConn. The Pirates led by DD's entering the 4Q, but was tied before scoring the GW td w/3:28 left. EC is 5-9 as a home dog & is on a 16-32 overall ATS run, while TU is 22-11 ATS away. Pirate QB Ahlers has thrown for 469 ypg over his L/3, but the Hurricane is #46 in our pass eff L/D. LW's surprising loss will have TU refocused, EC is all'g 521 ypg in AAC play, & we feel the Hurricane will cover in this series a 4th straight time.

PITTSBURGH by 6 over Boston College - This is only the 2nd ACC mtg between these 2 former Big East rivals. Pitt won the L/4 mtgs but they haven't met since '14. We picked up our 3rd straight College Totals GOY winner LW, going with Under 44 on Pitt vs VT! On a sloppy field in wet conditions the Panthers were shutout and held to a ssn low 177 yds. BC is playing B2B road gms after getting crushed by ND 40-7 (+2) and getting outgained 501-191. AJ Dillon was held to 56 (2.0) rush yds and now faces another stout rush D in Pitt who allows 93 (2.7). Pitt is +77 ypg and +41 ypg in ACC play. BC is -32 ypg and -17 ypg in ACC play. The Eagles are allowing 98 ypg more than their opp's avg (#127 in FBS). Pitt avg 9 ypg less than their opp's allow (#84 in FBS) and their 18.4 yds per point are among the worst in the country. HC Narduzzi is 7-12-1 as a HF while BC is on a 13-4 run as an AD and the Eagles must win to get bowl elig.

TENNESSEE by 24 over Vanderbilt - UT has lost 3 straight to Vandy under 3 different HC's and LY needed to win to get bowl elig but was outgained by 225 yds and lost 38-13 (+3). Vandy has covered 6 of the L/7. The 'Dores announced HC Mason would return next year and trounced FCS E Tenn St 38-0. Tenn is bowl eligible after beating MO for their 4th straight win. The Vols only won 24-20 (+4) despite a 526-280 yd edge. QB Guarantano threw for 415 yds and 3 different WR's topped 100 yds for the first time in school history. Tenn is +18 ypg and -19 ypg in SEC play. Vandy is -140 ypg and -246 ypg in SEC play. Against 5 common foes UT is 3-2 SU/ATS, -6 ppg & -16 ypg. Vandy is -14 SU/ATS, -23 ppg & -252 ypg. The Vols have covered 6 straight, while Vandy is on a 1-10 ATS run vs FBS foes, and Pruitt will want to put Vandy back in their place with a strong win.

Wake Forest by 10 over SYRACUSE - Cuse is 5-2 SU/ATS in this series & LY won 41-24 (-5) but got outg'd by 13 yds (Cuse +3 TO's). WF still has a shot at the ACC's Orange Bowl berth. The Deacons enter off a deceiving 38-27 (-6) home win over Duke. WF held Duke to 1 FD in the 1H, finished with 618-290 yd & 26-13 FD edges, was +3 TO's yet they trailed 27-26 4Q thanks to 2 KR td's and they settled for 4 fg's from Mr Automatic, Nick Sciba (FBS rec 32 consec made fg's). Cuse needed to win out to reach a bowl but gave up 608 yds & 56 pts in a 22 pt loss (+8) at Lville. QB DeVito was inj'd 4Q and didn't return (CS). The Orange allow 64 ypg more than their opp's allow and they've given up 516 ypg in their L/4 despite holding Duke to 279 2 wks ago. WF avg 59 ypg more than their opp's allow (#25 in FBS). Cuse is 1-5 as a dog TY and we have WF by DD's.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 11 over Texas St - Only prior mtg was is '17 when CC (-9) was held to 183 yds in a 27-7 loss. CC lost to ULM LW (45-42) & can't reach a bowl gm while TXSt's loss LW at App (35-13) dropped them to 2-17 SU in SBC road games the L5Y. Against 6 common SBC foes CC is 3-3 ATS & -102 ypg while TXSt is 1-4-1 ATS & -138 ypg. CC gave up just 260 ypg in non-conf play, but vs SBC foes they are all'g 468 ypg. CC's run OFF led by RB Marable (964, 504, 10 TD) avg's 164 ypg vs SBC foes but put up 463 yds the L/2 gms & now faces a TXSt run D all'g 211 ypg to SBC foes. TXSt has only put up over 350 yds in SBC play 2 times (held to 208 yds LW vs App) and struggle to run the ball (100 ypg in SBC play) but could take adv of a CC pass D that is missing 3 str's (pass eff D ranked #125). CC is 0-3 ATS as an SBC HF, but TXSt on a 2-8-1 ATS slide vs SBC foes.

Iowa St by 6 over KANSAS ST - It's Sr day in the Little Apple & KSt has won 24 of their L/29 home finales including 8 of 9. The host has won 4 of 6, but has failed to cover 3 of 4. The 'Cats had their 10 gm series win streak snapped LY, but did cover for just the 2nd time in the L/8 mtgs. ISU trailed by 17 pts in the 4Q, but came back and won 42-38 (-13) in the highest scoring game in series history! ISU has won 5 of 7 including B2B following their 41-31 (-24) win vs Kansas, ensuring the 'Clones 3 straight winning ssns for only the 2nd time in schl hist. ISU trailed by 3 entering the 4Q & took the lead for good w/5:10 left, but was slightly outg'd 493-489. KSt enters off a 30-27 (+2) win at Tx Tech as HC Klienman tied the schl rec for wins by a 1st yr HC. ISU is 10-3 ATS on the B12 road, is 5-1 as road chalk & is on a 28-15 overall ATS run, but KSt is 15-4 as a home dog, on a 13-5 overall ATS run & is 61-33 ATS vs B12 foes. We don't see much value here & we'll call for the 'Clones to win by just under a TD.

North Carolina by 14 over NC ST - NC is 0-2 ATS in the series despite losing the L/3 mtgs. The visitor is 5-1 ATS. LY's game was marred by a fight in the EZ after NCST's GW td in OT. Last Thurs NCST (+2) fell behind GT 21-3 at half. The 'Pack cut the deficit to 28-26 w/5:17 left but never got the ball back. NC is off a 56-7 (-38) win over FCS Mercer. The Tar Heels must win to reach a bowl while NCST won't be bowling for the first time since '13. NC is +41 ypg and +14 ypg in ACC play. NCST is +11 ypg but -63 ypg in ACC play. Against 3 common foes (WF, Clem & GT) NCST is 0-3 SU/ATS, -27 ppg & 117 ypg while NC is -1-2 SU/2-1 ATS, +3 ppg & +41 ypg. Both tms have banged up secondaries but NC has the far better QB in Sam Howell (58%, 32-6) against Devin Leary (50%, 7-3). The Tar Heels have been involved in a lot of close games but this won't be one of them. They have a clear motivation edge and a talent edge as well. NCST is on a 13-23-1 ATS run.

MARSHALL by 4 over FIU - FIU is 2-1 SU/3-0 ATS vs MU. LY the Herd did win 28-25 (-3) despite getting outgained 407-330. FIU enters off a program defining win over Miami 30-24 (+20). The Panthers led 16-0 2Q & never trailed but were outgained 413-297 & out FD'd 26-17. MU needed to win out to lock up a spot in the CUSA Title gm and was 7 pt chalk at Char. MU was held to 24-13. The Herd was held to 230 yds by a 49ers defense that was allowing 408 ypg on the ssn. MU can still reach the CUSA Title gm if FAU loses. FIU needs to win

to get bowl elig. MU is the better team on paper but their struggles as chalk are well documented (6-17-1 as CUSA chalk). FIU will be full of confidence after LW's upset and Butch Davis' squad will keep this close.

Baylor by 19 over KANSAS - It's Sr day in Lawrence, but KU has just 1 home finale win the L11Y, while BU is travelling for just the 2nd time the L/6 wks. In the series the Bears have won 9 straight by 35 ppg & has covered 7 in a row by 12 ppg! LY was the B12 opener for each & BU won 26-7 (-7). The Bears responded from their 1st loss by securing a spot in the B12 Title game after their 24-10 (-5) win vs TX. BU benefitted in the 2H from stopping the Horns on downs twice inside their own territory as well as gathering an int & QB Brewer is a ? (CS). KU enters having lost 7 of 8 including 3 straight by DD's following their 41-31 (+24) loss at Iowa St. The Jayhawks were outg'd by 111 ypg their prior 2 gms, but actually finished w/493-489 yd edge. BU is on a 11-4 overall ATS run, while KU is 5-8 as a home dog. While both teams already know where they stand as the ssn comes to an end, we feel the Bears, who are still pl'y for a playoff spot & assuming Brewer is ok, will call for BU to win by nearly 3 td's.

Clemson by 38 over SOUTH CAROLINA - Clemson has won 5 straight in the Palmetto Bowl by 23 ppg but SC has covered 3 of those 5 incl LY when they were 26 pt dogs and lost 56-35. The Gamecocks were able to keep that close because their OFF put up 600 yds incl 510 passing but this Tigers defense has yet to allow an opponent to reach 300 yds, is #1 in FBS holding foes 181 ypg below their avg and they are #2 in our pass eff D (47%, 6-13). Clemson enters fresh off a bye and since their 1 pt win vs NC they've outscored opp's by an avg score of 53-10. SC is also fresh off a bye and was held to a ssn low 260 yds at A&M. QB Lawrence has a 13-0 ratio in his L/4 and the Tigers avg 115 ypg more than their opp's allow #7 in FBS. Clemson is on a 17-3-1 ATS run vs FBS foes while SC has lost 4 of their L/5 SU & ATS.

MINNESOTA by 1 over Wisconsin - ESPN Gameday is making their 1st appearance in Minneapolis as the winner advances to the B10 Title game. It's Sr day in the Twin Cities, but MN has lost 6 of their L/7 home finales including LY. The Gophers snapped a 14 gm series losing streak in '18 & covered for the 1st time s/14. The host has failed to cover 5 straight. UW is pl'y w/ revenge as they failed to keep Paul Bunyan's Axe for the 1st time s/03 in LY's 37-15 (-11) loss and were held to their lowest pt total in the rivalry s/90! MN responded to their 1st loss with a 38-22 (-15) win at NW. QB Morgan was a ? but threw 4 td's as the Gophers had 23-14 FD & 423-223 yd edges. UW enters on a 3 gm win streak following their 45-24 (-24) win vs Purdue. While the Badgers finished w/31-20 FD & 606-376 yd edges, PU was twice SOD in UW territory in the 2H and the score wasn't as 1 sided as it appears. MN is 5-1 as a dog with 5 outright upsets! Over their L/4 gms the Gophers are +15 ppg & +143 ypg, while UW is +2 ppg & +39 ypg. We like the way HC Fleck has challenged this MN squad & feel the time is right for their 1st appearance in the B10 Championship.

PENN ST by 40 over Rutgers - It's Sr day in Happy Valley. As B10 rivals PSt is 5-0 SU, winning by 22 ppg, but RU has covered B2B. LY the Nittany Lions all'd a ssn low 46 pass yds, but only won 20-7 (-28). PSt enters off a misleading 28-17 (+19) loss at Ohio St after getting outg'd 417-227 & outFD'd 27-15 as they benefitted from a pair of scoring drives after TO's in their opponents territory & a fmb! recovery in their own EZ. RU enters off their 4th shutout loss, this time 27-0 (+21) vs Michigan St. The Knights were outFD'd 25-7 & outg'd 395-140 & were held under 100 pass yds for the 5th time TY! PSt is 21-12-1 ATS hosting B10 foes & is on a 29-16-1 overall ATS run, while RU is 2-8 as an away dog & is on a 2-8 overall ATS run. The Nittany Lions did hold the Buckeyes to a ssn low in ttl yds & RU is #128 FBS avg 119 ypg less than their opponents allow & we'll call for another blowout.

LIBERTY by 16 over New Mexico St - Aggies have lost 12 str reg ssn road finales, incl 28-21 here LY despite a 396-295 yard edge. This is the 4th mtg the L/2 yrs & the Flames have been favored for all 4. LY the Home team won both SU but NMST was 2-0 ATS. In their mtg on Oct 5th, the Flames won 20-13 as a 4 pt AD. The gm was tied 13-13 4Q & the Aggies finished with 24-20 fd & 396-334 yd edges but wore -3 TO's. This is the Flames first HG since mid-Oct & the road was rough as they went 1-3 SU (2-2 ATS) since incl 2 str losses. LW LU (+17) led Virginia 14-10 2Q but trailed 24-14 at HT & lost 55-27. After starting 0-9 SU (3-6 ATS), the Aggies won 2 straight SU & ATS but both were at home against an FCS foe & a UTEP tm that has won last 10 straight. NMST is just 2-4 ATS on the road. While the Flames have 6 wins, 2 are over FCS foes so they need to win here to qualify for their first ever bowl bid and we will look for them to get the win here.

UTAH by 34 over Colorado - Utah is 6-2 SU vs Colo as P-12 foes & have won the L/3 mtgs ATS (0-5 ATS prior). LY Utah (-7) went to Colo & held them to 196 yds in a 30-7 win (+3 TO's). LW Utah held Ariz to 196 yds and won 35-7 while Colo upset UW at home 20-14 & can reach a bowl. Utah's DEF is all'g P-12 foes just 246 ypg & 11 ppg while holding them to 191 ypg under their ssn avg. Colo's DEF is giving up 440 ypg & 31 ppg vs P-12 foes and allow them to gain 10 ypg above their ssn avg. Utah's OFF led by QB Huntley (2608, 75 ppg, 14-2) and RB Moss (1152, 6.4, 14 TD) is putting up 469 ypg & 36 ppg in P-12 play & should find success vs a Colo pass eff D ranked #98. Against 6 common P-12 foes Utah is 5-1 ATS & +186 ypg while Colo is 3-3 ATS & -16 ypg. Utah is 10-2 ATS the L4Y as a HF vs P-12 foes while Colo is 3-9-1 ATS the L3Y on the road in P-12 play. Utah is on a mission to make the CFP & won't overlook Colo even w/ the P-12 title gm on deck.

Charlotte by 7 over OLD DOMINION - ODU is 3-1 SU in this series but UC is 3-1 ATS & won LY 28-25 (+1) in a gm that was moved up 2 days at the last minute. Will Healy has done a remarkable job as UC HC, getting the 49ers bowl elig for the first time ever after their 24-13 (+7). The 49ers held the Herd to 230 yds (MU's 2nd lowest ttl of ssn) and finished w/+192 yd & +13 FD edges. ODU lost LW at MT 38-17 (+14) but they've found themselves a QB in true frosh Hayden Wolff who threw for a tm ssn high 321. The Monarchs outgained MT 423-391 but were SOD 3x, missed a fg and threw a pick 6. UC avg 28 ypg more than their opp's allow (#57 in FBS) while ODU avg 122 ypg less than their opp's allow (#129 in FBS) but the Monarchs have put up B2B ssn highs. UC still needs to win to guarantee a bowl but they've only been a HF once before and nearly lost to UTEP so we will call for ODU to keep it closer than expected.

Army +3 over HAWAII

Army over HAWAII - 5th mtg, UH is 3-1 SU/ATS but in their mtg LY at Army, the Black Knights (-6) held off a late rally by UH to win 28-21 (465-362). UH clinched their Div last wk with a 14-11 win over SDSt while Army is off a bye. Over their L/3 gms UH is all'g just 109 rush ypg (4.1 ypc) after all'g 214 ypg (5.9 ypc) their F/9 gms. Army's run game is avg'g 303 ypg (5.3 ypc) and face a UH run DEF that allowed 353 rush yds (6.9 ypc) to AF earlier this ssn. While UH is more known for their pass OFF (330 ypg, #7 FBS) they are avg'g 196 rush yds the L/5 wks incl rushing for 132 yds LW vs the 3rd-ranked rush D in the FBS. UH is just 2-16 as home chalk vs FBS foes. The Warriors have the MW Champ gm on deck & shouldn't want to risk players having to deal with the Army cut blocking, so we'll call for Army to pull the outright upset. **FORECAST: Army by 3**

WKU by 15 over Middle Tennessee - WKU is 3-1 SU/ATS and the home team is 4-1 SU/ATS. There has been 4 upsets in the L/7 mtgs and 6 of the L/8 have been decided by 5 pts or less. HC Helton pulled his 5th outright upset of the season in WKU's 28-10 (+7) win at SM. MT beat ODU 38-17 (-14) that was outgained by 32 yds and allowed the Monarchs to put up a ssn high 423 yds. WKU is +46 ypg and +41 ypg at home. MT is -55 ypg and -133 ypg on the road. The Toppers hold foes 81 ypg below their avg (#21 in FBS). MT allows 91 ypg more than foes avg (#122 in FBS). QB Storey has a 5-0 ratio in his L/3 and faces our #101 pass eff D who just let ODU's true fresh QB throw for over 300. WKU is 8-0 SU/6-2 on Senior day and we think there is value after MT's deceiving win over a bad team.

AIR Force by 9 over Wyoming - WY is 6-4 vs AF the L/10 yds & are 10-0 ATS in that span! AF won their 6th gm in a row LW over NMex 44-22 while WY won a close gm (17-7) over CSU last Fri. It will strength vs strength as AF's run attack that puts up 315 ypg (5.3 ypc) in MW play, goes up against a WY run D that allows just 99 ypg (3.1) vs MW foes. WY avg'd 262 rush ypg with QB Chambers the F/4 gms of MW play, but since he went OFY (knee) WY is avg'g 158 rush ypg the L/3 gms. AF's run D holds MW foes to just 94 ypg & overall their DEF holds conf foes to 106 ypg under their ssn avg. WY did hold Boise to 285 yds 3 wks ago & they hold MW foes to 69 ypg under their ssn avg. Since '12 AF is 13-25 ATS as MW chalk while WY is 13-6 ATS as a MW dog. With both teams running the ball, pass will be at a premium & we see WY keeping it close.

SAN JOSE ST by 1 over Fresno ST - Fresno leads series 42-37-3. Home tm is also 5-2-1 ATS the L/8 mtgs. Both teams sit at 4 wins & cannot make a bowl. Against 5 common MW foes, Fresno is 2-3 SU & -83 ypg while SJS is 0-5 SU & -47 ypg. Fresno has been able to run the ball well vs MW foes, avg'g 154 yds (5.1 ypc) but the L/2 gms have just 123 rush yds & SJS has taken up 253 rush ypg (5.9 ypc) to MW foes. However SJS has the #4 pass OFF in the FBS (342 ypg) led by QB Love (3633, 60%, 22-8) and they face a Fresno pass D that has all'd 307 pass ypg the L/5 gms incl all'g SDSt to throw for 300+ yds for the 1st time since 2014 and Fresno is all'g MW foes to gain 63 ypg above their avg. SJS is on a 6-2 ATS run at home vs MW foes & are on a 7-3 ATS run this ssn while Fresno is just 2-5 ATS this ssn in MW play.

Rice by 6 over UTEP - UTEP snapped their 20 gm losing streak LW vs Rice 34-26 (+1). Prior to LY's meeting Rice had won 10 of 12 prev mtgs and were on a 13-2 ATS run. After starting the ssn 0-9, Rice has now won 2 straight, incl upsets over MT & NT. LW the Owls (+6) held the Mean Green to a ssn low 238 yds despite the return of NT QB Fine. Rice led 20-0 & held a 228-51 yd edge at half. UTEP enters off a 44-35 (+7) loss at rival NMST. The Miners held the yds edge for the first time all ssn & led 21-16 4Q. UTEP has lost their L/13 vs FBS foes since LY's win over Rice. The Miners are 4-13 as a HD. Rice hasn't been in AF since 2015.

NEVADA by 10 over UNLV - Rivalry started in '69 & they play for the Fremont Cannon. Since '05 Nev is 11-3 SU /9-5 ATS vs UNLV. Last ssn Nev (-14) led 23-0 early 2Q but UNLV mounted their biggest comeback ever & won 34-29, so Nev will be out for revenge. Against 5 common MW foes Nev is 3-2 SU, -68 ypg, -13 ypg while UNLV is 1-4 SU, -102 ypg, -16 ppg. After running for 168 ypg vs MW foes last ssn, UNLV is only avg'g 129 rush yds per gm (3.9 ypc) & over the last 3 gms Nev's run D is giving up just 92 ypg (2.9 ypc). Nev only avg'd 58 rush yds (1.9 ypc) in their previous 3 gms, but LW ran for 254 yds vs Fresno & do face a UNLV run D that gives up 203 ypg (5.8 ypc) to MW foes. With UNLV going 1-6 ATS as an AD the L/2Y & Nev 5-1 ATS as a MW HF under Norvell, we'll back the Pack.

Indiana by 6 over PURDUE - It's Sr day in West Lafayette. PU had lost 4 straight but has now won the Old Oaken Bucket in B2B seasons for the 1st time s/2011-12. The Boilermakers have covered 3 straight in the series & are on a 7-3 ATS run when hosting. LW was a must win for both teams to achieve bowl eligibility & PU scored the game deciding wd w/34:48 left & won 28-21 (-3). This game will have a little bit of a different feel as Indy has played this game with bowl eligibility on the line each of the L/4Y, but is already in-line for post ssn play despite entering with B2B losses following their 39-14 (+9) setback vs Michigan. The Hoosiers were out'd 45:32-PU is staying home for the holidays for the 1st time under HC Brohm following their 45-24 (+24) loss at Wisconsin. Despite being out'd 606-376 & outFD'd 31-20, the Boilermakers were SOD twice inside Badger territory in the 2H. Indy is 0-4 as road chalk, while PU HC Brohm is 21-12 ATS in home games. We'll call for PU to continue their ATS series dominance in this rivalry as Brohm will have them playing for pride.

LSU by 12 over Texas A&M - LSU was 7-0 SU/ATS vs A&M until LY's mtg when the Aggies (-3) won in 7 OT 74-72. LSU was 6th in TD rank yet only led Ark 7-6 2Q LW then scored 49 straight before the Hogs added 2 pbq time tds. A&M finishes with B2B road gms after their 19-13 loss at UGA LW. The Aggies held UGA to 260 yds and finished with +14 yd & +4 FD edges. The Aggies didn't reach the EZ until the 4Q and finished with -1 rush yd. LSU avg 561 ypg & 182 ypg more than their opp's allow (#2 in FBS). A&M allows 321 ypg and holds foes 90 ypg below their avg (#16 in FBS). A&M has our #16 ranked pass eff D. Joe Burrow has already seen our #11, #13 & #23 pass eff D's. HC Fisher is 4-1 as an AD but and the Tigers have the SEC Title gm on deck.

Louisville by 3 over KENTUCKY - UL is 6-2 SU/4-3-1 ATS vs KY. The visitor has won 4 straight incl LY when KY smoked UL 56-10 (-17). UL showed no letdown in their first game since getting bowl elig, beating Cuse 56-34 (-8). RB Hawkins is #2 in the ACC and rushed for 233. KY won easily over an FCS foe LW. The 'Cats have limited their opp's possessions since switching to a run based offense under former WR Bowden. They've held their L/5 foes to under 300 yds. QB Cunningham has a 19-4 ratio and faces our #21 pass eff D. UL is +14 ypg while KY is +58 ypg but the Cards have faced the tougher skid (#41 vs #57). KY is 3-12 as a HF and HC Satterfield has pulled a couple outright upsets this year so we will give UL a 3 pt edge.

LOUISIANA by 20 over Ulm - ULL leads the "Battle on the Bayou" 28-25 & since '08 are 9-2 SU. However the home tm is just 2-17-1 ATS since '99 and there have been 12 outright upsets incl each of the last 2 ssn's. ULL locked up a return trip to the SBC title gm last wk (53-3 win over Troy) while ULM kept their slim bowl hopes alive w/ a 45-42 win vs CC. ULL's run gm continues to excel (#5 FBS) as they avg 276 yds (6.6 ypc) as their top 5 rushers all avg at least 5.8 ypc. ULL's run DEF ranks #127 as they have all'd 252 ypg (5.7 ypc) this ssn. ULL is led by dual threat QB Evans (3326 ttl yds, 30 ttl TD's) & RB Johnson (1189, 63, 11 TD) but face a ULL DEF that holds SBC foes to 342 ypg & 46 ypg under their ssn avg. Against 6 common SBC foes ULL is 4-2 ATS, +98 ypg, +17 ypg while ULL is 1-5 ATS, -21 ypg, -8 ppg. ULL is 2-3-1 ATS as a SBC HF under Napier & while we like ULL to win, the series history has us thinking ULM stays within the line.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 13 over Georgia ST - 6th mtg, with GS holding a 3-2 SU lead. Home team is just 1-3-1 ATS. LY GS (-10) snapped a 3 gm losing skid to GST, winning 35-14 (381-264). GS comes in off a loss at Ark ST 38-33 while GST is off a 28-15 win vs SAla. GS's run DEF is giving up 205 ypg (5.3 ypc) & faces a GS team that puts up 266 rush ypg vs SBC foes. GST faced an option team in Army earlier this ssn & gave up 278 rush yds, but won 28-21. Against 6 common SBC foes GS is 4-2 SU & -12 ypg while GST is 4-2 SU & +48 ypg. GS's QB Ellington is still playing despite a torn ACL but has been hit or miss & GST RB Barnett (1336, 61, 11 TD) is carrying the load on OFF. GS gives up 145 rush ypg & 2 wks ago held ULM (avg'g 206 rush yds) to just 85 yds. GST is 1-2 ATS since the QB inj & GS should be able to run all over a weak GK defense.

ILLINOIS by 1 over Northwestern - It's Sr day in Champaign, but IL has lost 10 of their L/11 home finales while scoring just 1 td in their L/10 in those games! NW has won 7 of their L/8 road finales. The 'Cats have won the Land of Lincoln Trophy 4 straight years, tying for their longest winning streak in the series and had covered 3 straight prior to LY. In that '18 matchup NW had already secured a trip to the B10 Title game & was held to just 110 pass yds, but still won 24-16 (-17). IL needs TO's to stay competitive, but was on the wrong end LW (-2) and lost at Iowa 19-10 (+15) snapping their 4 gm streak to NW meanwhile, just 1Y removed from a B10 Title game appearance, is playing for pride & has lost 8 of 9 following their 38-22 (+15) loss vs MN. IL is 17-29 as home chalk, while NW is 29-11 as an away dog. Against 6 common foes (NU/MN/WUP/MST/IO) IL is -152 ypg, while NW is -49 ypg! We'll call for the 'Cats to keep this game closer than expected.

MICHIGAN ST by 23 over Maryland - It's Sr day in East Lansing & MST has won 9 of their L/12 home finales. As B10 rivals Sparty is 4-1 SU, but has failed to cover 2 of the L/3Y & the visitor in the series has covered B2B. LY despite having Ohio ST on deck, MST held MD to ssn lows in rush & ttl yards and won 24-3 (-2). Sparty kept their bowl hopes alive after snapping their 5 gm losing streak & shutting out Rutgers 27-0 (-21) LW, all'g just 7 FD's & 140 ttl yds. The Terps meanwhile, were fresh off a bye LW, but still got blown out a 4th straight gm, this time 54-7 (+6) vs

Nebraska. 2 more QB's were inj'd (CS) for MD as they were outFD'd 31-9 & out'd 531-206. MD is 4-12 as an away dog. We'll call for MST, who is #20 FBS on D holding foes to 83 ypg below their avg, to become bowl eligible as the Terps get blown out for a 5th straight game.

Oklahoma by 10 over OKLAHOMA ST - It's Sr day in Stillwater & OKSt has lost 4 straight Bedlam games, their longest losing streak since losing 8 in a row from 2003-10. OU had covered 3 straight prior to LY & the visitor is on a 6-1 ATS series run. In the '18 matchup the Sooners all'd a td w/1:03 left, but the 2 pt conv was no good & OU held on to win 48-47 (-21). The Sooners secured a berth in the B12 Title game after beating CUT 28-24 (-18). OU finished w/511-204 yd & 30-11 FD edges but were -2 TO's. The Pokes have a new sf qb in Hawaii trans Brown & were able to get past WV 20-13 (-14) despite being out'd 333-285. OKSt trailed entering the 4Q but took the lead w/11:23 left & added a fg w/6:18 remaining. OKSt is on a 11-5 overall ATS run & OU has been in a 1 pass gm in 5 of their L/6 including 4 straight & we'll call for a closer than expected outcome.

LOUISIANA TECH by 17 over Utsa - LT has won 5 str meetings and covered the L/3 by 11.8 ppg. Utsa has scored 9 pts ttl in the L/2 meetings. LT gets QB Smith and WR Hardy back this week after missing the L/2 which they lost at Marshall & UAB. The Bulldogs (+6) trailed 20-7 4Q and scored with 3:01 left, giving Utsa trailed 27-3 3Q vs FAU LW. The RoadRunners were down 40-18 (+20) 4Q and scored with 3:01 left, giving Utsa trailed a backdoor cover. LT is +52 ypg & 112 ypg at home. Utsa is -84 ypg and -125 ypg on the road. LT struggled the last 2 weeks on offense but Smith is back at the helm and Utsa is giving up 69 ypg more than their opp's allow. LT is currently in a 3-way tie for the CUSA West and we think they win but Utsa has covered 3 straight as an AD.

FAU by 7 over Southern Miss - These 2 only met once. FAU won 41-7 (-17) in '13. SM outgained WKU 388-365 last week but lost at WKU 28-10 (-7). FAU enters off a 40-26 (-20) win over Utsa. The Owls led 27-3 3Q and 40-19 4Q but Utsa got a backdoor cover when the RoadRunners scored with 3:01 left. SM is +71 ypg and +120 ypg in CUSA play. FAU is +45 ypg and +102 ypg in CUSA play. The Golden Eagles avg 54 ypg more than opp's allow (#32 in FBS). FAU avg 63 ypg more than their opp's allow (#23 in FBS). The Owls are +158 ypg in their L/4 while SM is +118 in their L/4. Both tms need a win to possibly clinch their division. SM could be w/o QB Abraham who left late w/in inj vs WKU (CS). HC Kiffin is 15-7 ATS vs CUSA foes and we will call for the Owls to clinch the CUSA East with a 7 point win.

SMU by 3 over Tulane - It's Sr day in Dallas. SMU is on a 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS run in the series, but the visitor has covered 3 straight. TU is p/lyg with revenge after they failed to hold onto a 4Q lead for the 3rd straight mtg vs the Ponies and lost 27-23 (-7). The Wave are bowl eligible, but enter having lost 4 of 5 following their 34-31 (+6) loss vs UCF. TU trailed 24-7 2H, but never quit. After scoring w/26 left, they failed to recover the outside. SMU saw their AAC Title & NYD Bowl chances disappear following their 35-28 (+3) loss at Navy. The Ponies were out'd 540-344 & outFD'd 28-15, but was tied mid 4Q & SOD from the Navy (+2) w/2:40 left. SMU all'd 378 (5.2) rush vs Navy's option LW & while the Green Wave also runs the option, it's a different enough version to keep the Ponies defense on edge. TU is on a 8-3 overall ATS run & we'll call for a closer than expected outcome.

UCLA by 3 over California - UCLA leads the series 54-33-1 & the Bruins have won 6 of the L/8 gms SU. Since 2000 the home team is 16-3 SU/14-4-1 ATS. LY UCLA (+7) was +5 in TO's and won 37-7 for their 1st win of the ssn. UCLA is off a 52-35 loss to USC & can't get to a bowl, while Cal won at rival Stanford 24-20 & are bowl elig. Cal QB Garbers was inj'd 2 wks ago but LW hit 20-30 for 285 yds. Aside from their trip to Utah 2 wks ago (269 yds, 3 pts) the Bruin OFF has avg'd 487 yds & 37 pts vs P-12 foes & they face a Cal DEF that has all'd over 400 yds in 4 of their L/6 gms, but do have the #33 pass eff D. Aside from a 3 gm stretch vs Stan, AZST, Colo (all'd 288 ypg) UCLA has all'd 525 ypg, but face a Cal OFF that is avg'g just 285 yds in P-12 play. Cal is an impressive 5-1 ATS as an AD vs P-12 foes the L/2Y while UCLA is just 1-4 ATS under HC Kelly as home chalk.

Notre Dame by 16 over STANFORD - It's Sr day on the Farm. Stanford had won the Legends Trophy 3 straight years prior to LY, but has failed to cover 5 of the L/7 in this series. While the host is on a 9-2 SU run, the home team has failed to cover 8 of the L/13Y. LY both were ranked Top 10, but ND had 29-10 FD & 550-229 yd edges & won 38-17 (-5). Stanford is staying home for the holidays for the 1st time s/'08 following their 24-20 (-1) loss vs Cal. The Cardinal are down to bkp QB Mills & were out'd 424-344 & outFD'd 22-15. The Irish have won 4 straight following following their 40-7 (-21) blowout over BC, finishing w/277-117 FD & 501-191 yd edges. The Irish are doing it with defense as they've held 4 straight foes to over 100 yds below their ssn avg. ND is 8-4-2 as chalk away from South Bend & is on a 9-4-1 overall ATS run in the reg ssn. We'll call for the upward trending Irish to win by over 2 td's.

ARIZONA ST by 17 over Arizona - Battle for Territorial Cup, Ariz leads 49-42-1. Home team has dominated of late going 5-1 SU/6-0 ATS. ASU snapped a 4 gm losing streak LW, upsetting Oregon 31-28, while Ariz started 4-1 but has lost 6 straight. Ariz's DEF has struggled all ssn, giving up 484 ypg & 37 ppg, while their OFF has been shut down the L/2 gms (436 yds, 13 pts) vs Oregon & Utah. Against 6 common P-12 foes ASU is -1-5 ATS & -76 ypg while Ariz is 1-5 ATS & -111 ypg. ASU RB Benjamin (915, 4, 2) is having a down ssn, but could be out & break here vs an Ariz run D that is all'g 203 ypg vs P-12 foes. Both tms have struggled this ssn, but ASU just locked up a bowl bid w/ a win LW & are more motivated and have the better coach. Given the recent history also, we will back the home team.

Utah St by 18 over NEW MEXICO - 26th mtg, NMex leads 13-12. As MW foes USU 4-2 SU/3-3 ATS & have won the L/2 mtgs both SU/ATS. USU lost 56-21 at Boise LW while NMex dropped their 8th gm in a row 44-22 vs Air Force. USU QB Love (2913, 61%, 14-15) has had a down ssn, but could get on track this week vs a NMex pass eff D ranked #129 & the Lobos all'd AF to throw for 327 yds LW! NMex could be on their 4th QB of the ssn (Tuioti left gm LW w/ inj, CS) & leading rusher RB Davis (832, 5.9) is OFY. Against 5 common MW foes NMex is 0-5 SU & -120 ypg while USU is 3-2 SU & -16 ypg. NMex is just 4-11 ATS the L/2Y vs MW foes & has nothing to play for & are down nearly 30 scholarship players while USU needs the win to solidify their bowl hopes.

Miami, FL by 17 over DUKE - Duke ended a 4 gm series losing streak LW, upsetting the 'Canes 20-12 (+9) despite getting outgained 411-290. LW Miami became the first time in at least 40Y to lose 3 games as a 2 td chalk in the same season, losing 30-24 (-20) to cross-town rival FIU. UM held 413-297 yd & 26-17 FD edges but were -3 TO's. Duke's 12 pt loss last week might be the most deceiving close loss of the ssn. They were outgained 618-290, -3 TO's but lost 39-27 (+6) and were covering until WF scored with 3:27 left. Duke got 2 KR td's and WF settled for 4 fg's. UM is +82 ypg and +39 ypg in ACC play. Duke is -57 ypg and -71 ypg in ACC play. Duke avg 69 ypg less than their opp's allow and they've been held under 300 yds in 3 str (2 OFF td's in L/3 gms). UM holds foes 81 ypg below their avg. The 'Canes have won & covered after all 3 SU losses this year so we will call for the revenge minded 'Canes to win by more than 2 td's.

SAN DIEGO ST by 1 over BYU - BYU is on a 12-2 SU/10-4 ATS run vs SDSt, but last met in the Poinsettia Bowl in '12 (BYU won 23-6). Both team are going bowling this year, but BYU has won 5 in a row & are avg'g 506 yds & 40 pts over that span. SDSt has lost 2 of their last 3 gms & have avg'd 351 yds & 14 pts. All but 2 of SDSt's gms have been decided by 10 pts or less & win games w/ their DEF, all'g just 277 ypg, 14 ppg & hold foes to 123 under their ssn avg (#7 FBS). BYU's DEF the L/2 gms has all'd just 282 ypg, but faced Idaho ST & UMass, in their 9 previous gms they all'd 420 ypg. BYU has put up 208 rush ypg, (5.0 ypc) & 319 pass ypg the L/4 gms, but go against a run D giving up just 72 ypg (2.6 ypc) and a pass eff D ranked #17. BYU is 0-3 ATS under Sitake as an AF, and SDSt is 30-9 SU the L/6 ssns at home & behind a strong DEF pick up another close win.

OREGON by 16 over Oregon ST - 123rd meeting in the "Civil War" rivalry. Since '08 OU is 10-1 SU/7-4 ATS incl a 55-15 drubbing of OSU last ssn despite QB Herbert leaving 2Q w/ inj. UO got their CFP hopes burst LW with an upset loss at Ariz ST (31-28) while OSU led Wash ST 53-42 late 4Q, but all'd 2 late TD's & lost 54-53 and now need a win here to get to a bowl. Against 6 common P-12 foes OU is 3-3 ATS & +82 ypg while OSU is 4-1-1 ATS & -27 ypg. UO QB Herbert could be in for a big day facing the #105 pass eff D. While OSU QB Luton (408 yds, 5 td LW vs Wash ST) faces a UO DEF that has just all'd 408 pass yds to Ariz TM LW. OSU is on a 6-1 ATS run as a P-12 AD & 4 of their L/5 gms have been decided by 12 pts or less. Home team is 3-10 ATS s/'06 & we'll lean w/ the road dog.

4★ LA Chargers over DENVER - Following a blown 20 pt lead in MIN and a 20-3 defeat at BUF (held to just 9 FD's & 134 yds!), the Broncos return to "Mile High" for their only HG in a 5-week span (trips to HOU & KC on deck). The Chargers meanwhile are returning to action after a late ssn bye. Prior to their week off, LA dropped a 7 pt contest in Mexico City against DIV rival KC who forced QB Rivers into 4 more int's (3 int's the week prior vs OAK). In LA's earlier home meeting with DEN TY, the Broncos jumped out to a 17-0 HT lead before having to hold on late in the 20-13 victory (DEN 350-246 yd edge, 2nd consec road upset of the Chargers). After losing 5 in a row ATS following their bye from '11-'15, the Chargers have cashed 3 in a row after their week off. With DEN having failed to cover 6 of their L/7 as a DIV HD, we'll go ahead and call for the Chargers to even up the season series.

3★ NY Jets over CINCINNATI - The Jets are on an impressive run over the past 3 wks with wins over the Giants, Redskins & Raiders (3★ Newsletter Winner, 21-10 FD & 401-208 yd edges in 31 pt victory) to make HC Gase's seat much cooler as the season heads into its final month. CIN on the other hand is still in search of their 1st win in '19 following a 6 pt home loss a week ago against the Steelers where we captured an easy Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner on "Under 38". In their most recent meeting back in the '16 ssn, the Bengals connected on a 47-yd FG w/54 left to get the 23-22 comeback victory. While CIN has gone an impressive 11-4 ATS as a NDIV HD coming in, the Jets have won 6 of the past 9 overall in this series and appear to be a "play-on" team at the moment following their recent success. **FORECAST: NY Jets by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ ARIZONA over LA Rams - Following a much-needed late ssn bye, the Cardinals are in Glendale for the 1st of 3 consec HG's. The Rams meanwhile are traveling on short rest after their MNF home matchup against the red-hot Ravens. In their 2 meetings of a year ago, the Cardinals were clearly outmatched as the Rams picked up easy victories at both home (34-0, -13) and on the road (31-9, -14). While ARZ also suffered some significant beatdowns in '17 with the Rams winning by a combined margin of 65-16, there's plenty to like about this '19 version of the Cardinals as they're on a 5-1-1 ATS run coming in including a trio of outright upset victories. With the Rams back at home next week in a key NFC West battle with the Seahawks followed by 2 more key road trips to DAL & SF, this is clearly a spot that they could be caught looking ahead in.

THURSDAY November 28th:

Chicago by 6 over DETROIT - 17th Thanksgiving meeting dating back to 1934. The Bears 23-16 (-3) victory LY saw them take a 9-8 series edge in this holiday matchup. After dominating their opponents from '13-'16 with a perfect 4-0 SU & ATS mark (20 pt avg MOV), DET has slipped up the past 2 years. The Lions lost for the 7th time in their L/8 gms LW on the road at WAS with the Redskins getting a GW 39-yd FG w/16 left (DET 364-230 yd edge, 4-2 TO deficit). The Bears meanwhile head into action following a victory against the Giants where they finished with a 335-243 yd edge. In their prior '19 matchup 18 days ago, the Bears picked up a 20-13 win (-6) despite DET finishing with a 357-226 yd advantage. With the Lions struggling as a recent HD at just 6-13 ATS overall and the Bears picking up ATS victories in 9 of their L/10 inside of the NFC North, we're giving the visitor the lean in this one.

DALLAS by 3 over Buffalo - The Bills and Cowboys were dominant franchises back in the 1990's with a combined 7 appearances in the Super Bowl including 2 head-to-head matchups ('92 & '93) that saw DAL claim 52-17 & 30-13 victories. Following a 17 pt home victory LW against the Broncos where they all'd just 3 pts, 9 FD's & 134 tl yds, the Bills head South to take on a DAL squad that they knocked off 16-6 (-6) in their most recent meeting back in '15 (408-307 yd edge). DAL meanwhile returns home after a 13-9 loss in Foxboro to the Patriots where they were held to 20 pts & 124 yds under their ssn avg's. The Cowboys have failed to cover 7 of their L/8 overall on Thanksgiving but did get the narrow cover a ssn ago against the Redskins (31-23, -7). With the Bills on a solid 9-3-1 ATS run coming in, we'll cut off our DAL lean at just a FG in this matchup.

New Orleans at ATLANTA - TNF - After spending the first 8 weeks of the ssn playing contests outside of their DIV, the Falcons host the Saints for their 4th consec NFC South matchup. The first 2 contests went surprisingly well with ATL picking up SU & ATS victories on the road at NO & CAR. LW's home matchup against the Bucs didn't go in a positive direction however as TB finished with a 446-337 yd edge in the 35-22 win. In their Wk 10 trip to the Superdome, the Falcons (off a bye) dominated the Saints by forcing 6 sks and not allowing a TD in the 26-9 upset win as a 13' pt dog (ended NO's 3-game series winning streak). While the Saints have gotten back on track in each of the past 2 weeks against DIV rivals TB & CAR (GW 33-yd FG as time expired, 418-351 yd edge), backing their revenge trip to ATL by too much could be dangerous as the Falcons have covered 6 in a row as a DIV HD dating back to '09 including 3 outright upsets in that span. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

SUNDAY December 1st:

Green Bay by 10 over NY GIANTS - The Packers continue to struggle in the "Golden State" as the 49ers became the 2nd team in California to dominate them (GB outscored by a combined 64-18 vs LAC & SF). The Giants also came up on the losing end in their trip to Soldier Field as the Bears held them to just 14 FD's & 243 yds in the 19-14 victory. In their most recent meeting back in the '16 season, the Packers finished with 23-14 FD & 406-219 yd edges in the 23-16 win while snapping a 2-game series losing streak in the process. With GB now sitting tied atop the NFC North standings with MIN following their loss to SF and the Giants having failed to cover 8 of their L/9 as a HD, we have no issue giving the visitor the DD lean in this contest.

CAROLINA by 13 over Washington - After an outstanding 4-0 SU & ATS start with QB Allen under center, the Panthers have fallen short in 4 of their past 5 (2-3 ATS) including a 3 pt loss LW in the Superdome where they missed a 28-yd FG w/1:56 left and NO connected on a GW 33-yd FG as time expired. The Redskins meanwhile lost some ground in the battle for the #1 pick in next year's draft as they overcame a 364-230 yd deficit to survive 19-16 at home against the Lions (GW 39-yd FG w/16 left). In the Panthers' trip to D.C. a year ago, the Redskins (-1) picked up a 23-17 victory despite CAR finishing with a 350-288 yd edge. With WAS on just a 3-7 ATS run coming in and the Panthers needing a solid victory here to keep their remote playoff chances alive, we'll go ahead and back the home team in this one despite their recent troubles.

BALTIMORE by 7 over San Francisco - Rematch of SB XLVII ('12 ssn), a game that saw BAL and John Harbaugh claim a 34-31 victory over brother Jim Harbaugh and the 49ers (power outage caused a delay in the 3Q). These 2 could very well be on a collision course to meet for the Lombardi Trophy once again as BAL went into their MNF matchup against the Rams with the 2nd best mark in the AFC at 8-2 while the 49ers moved to 10-1 on the ssn following an easy 29 pt win over the Packers on SNF that saw them hold the visitor to just 8 pts and 198 yds. While the 49ers covered just 2 of their 7 matchups as an AD a year ago, they are a perfect 2-0 SU & ATS this ssn with a 14 pt avg MOV. Despite that impressive '19 mark, we're backing the Ravens in this one as they're on a 4-0 ATS run overall as of presstime with a 22 pt avg cover in that span.

INDIANAPOLIS by 7 over Tennessee - Following a Thur night matchup against HOU where they came up just short in a 3 pt defeat, IND is back at home for the only time in a 4-wk span to take on TEN. The Titans meanwhile returned from bye with a 22 pt win over JAX that saw RB Henry run for 159 yds & 2 TD's. In their Wk 2 matchup in Nashville, the Colts picked up their 14th win in 16 tries against the Titans thanks to a GW 4-yd TD pass w/4:38 remaining. With IND now on a 6-0 ATS run inside of the AFC South and TEN having failed to cover 11 of their past 12 as a DIV AD, we have no problem giving the home squad a TD lean in this one.

Philadelphia by 10 over MIAMI - Following a 2nd straight defeat a week ago on the road in CLE where the Browns finished with a 467-284 yd edge in the 41-24 win, the Dolphins are back inside of South Beach for the only time in a 4-week span to take on the Eagles. PHI saw their NFC playoff hopes take a pretty significant hit over the past 2 weeks after home losses to the Patriots and Seahawks (2★ Newsletter Winner on SEA!). In the most recent matchup in this series ('15), the Dolphins overcame a sluggish start (trailed 16-3 at PHI) to earn the come-from-behind 20-19 win (PHI 29-15 FD & 436-289 yd edges). Although the Eagles failed to cover 4 of their L/5 against the AFC coming in, they have won and covered 2 of their 3 non-conf meetings in '19. With MIA coming back to reality following an impressive span in which they covered 5 in a row while claiming a pair of upset victories, we expect them to drop their 8th cover in 11 matchups with the NFC.

KANSAS CITY by 13 over Oakland - Battle for first place in the AFC West. Arrowhead Stadium has been a house of horrors for OAK QB Carr who is 0-5 all-time with a porous 3-5 ratio. LW's trip to MetLife Stadium nearly proved to be just as bad as the Raiders were held to just 10 FD's & 208 yds in the 34-3 blowout defeat (3★ Newsletter Winner on NYJ!). The Chiefs meanwhile picked up a key victory on MNF in Mexico City prior to their week off despite a less than average day from QB Mahomes (182 pass yds, 1-1 ratio). With HC Reid an outstanding 17-3 SU following a bye week including a 7 pt win LY against the Raiders inside of the "Black Hole", we'll go ahead and call for the Chiefs to earn the season sweep (28-10 at OAK in Wk 2) while taking command inside of the DIV.

JACKSONVILLE by 1 over Tampa Bay - While these two teams have had their fair share of '19 struggles, the Bucs did pick up a surprising 35-22 upset win LW in ATL against the Falcons with WR Godwin pulling in 184 yds & a pair of TD's (TB 446-337 yd edge). The Jaguars meanwhile couldn't stop the Titans offense LW in Nashville in a 42-20 defeat (TEN 471-369 yd edge). In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Bucs overcame a late 3Q home deficit to knock off JAX by a 38-31 score (-2). While TB has failed to cover 4 of their L/5 against the AFC heading into this road contest, the Jaguars have been equally as dismal in non-conf games with just a 4-23 ATS mark. With no value for either squad in this one, we're putting our forecast right at the opening line.

PITTSBURGH by 4 over Cleveland - If you shut off your TV before the end of the previous matchup just 17 days ago, then you missed more than just CLE's 21-7 victory as a late ruckus saw Browns' DE Garrett susp for the rest of the ssn after hitting bkp QB Rudolph in the head with his own helmet. The Steelers got back into the win column for the 5th time in the L/6 gms a week ago in CIN (3.5★ Top Play LP Winner on "Under 38") although Rudolph was benched to start the 2H making his status for this contest unknown (#3 QB Hodges 5-11-118-1-0 in relief). The Browns meanwhile earned a 17 pt home win over the Dolphins with QB Mayfield throwing for 327 yds & 3 TD's. While the Steelers could be without a few of their offensive contributors including C Pouncey who is serving the 2nd of his 2 gm suspension during the same late game fallout in CLE, they are on an outstanding 12-4-1 ATS run as a HD dating back to the beginning of the 2000 campaign! **New England at HOUSTON - SNF** - While the Patriots were on an outstanding 8-1 ATS run as a NDIV AF heading into '18, the past 2 years have seen them cover just 3 of their L/8. They are however off of a pair of solid non-conf victories against the Eagles & Cowboys to stay ahead of the Ravens atop the AFC playoff standings. The Texans are back at home with extra rest following their Thur night victory over the Colts where they finished with a 396-296 yd edge. In HOU's ssn opening trip to Foxboro a year ago, QB Brady threw for 277 yds & 3 TD's in the 27-20 victory (-6). Despite covering just 1 of their L/5 contests as a HD coming in, this is the 2nd of 3 consec HG's for the Texans while the Patriots have a huge meeting at home against the Chiefs on deck. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

MONDAY December 2nd:

Minnesota at SEATTLE - MNF - This marks the only HG in a 4-wk span for the Seahawks as they return to the Pacific NW following a 17-9 win against the Eagles (2★ Newsletter Winner!). The Vikings meanwhile are back from a late ssn bye although their record following a week off has been poor with covers in just 2 of their past 9 contests. In their MNF trip to SEA a year ago, the Vikings needed a 6 yd TD pass with 1:10 left to avoid being shut out in the 21-7 defeat. From '14-'15 the Vikings were an outstanding 10-3 ATS as an AD. Since then, they've covered just 5 of 14 in that role. If they're going to improve that mark in front of the "12th Man", QB Cousins will have to be much sharper than he's been in recent primetime appearances (just 6-13 SU & ATS on Thur, Sun & Mon nights in his career).
