SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - MERCEDEZ-BENZ STADIUM - ATLANTA, GA

3★ Lsu over Georgia - This is the 4th meeting between these two in the SEC Title game, with LSU winning twice including the Tigers last trip here in 2011 42-10 (-13). LSU is 4-1 SU/2-1-1 ATS in SEC Title games. UGA is playing in their 3rd straight SEC Title game after last year's 35-28 (+12) loss vs Alabama. The Dawgs are 3-4 SU/5-2 ATS in SEC Title games. LSU has covered the last meetings vs UGA and won 3 of the L4. When these two met last year, UGA was #2 and just over 7 point chalk, but LSU jumped to a 16-0 lead with a 246-124 yd edge at half and went on to win by 20 points. The chalk is on an 8-3-1 ATS run in the SEC Title game. UGA has won 6 straight games after last week's 52-7 (-28) beatdown of GT. Three of UGA's L5 wins have been decided by 7 points or less. LSU enters off a dominating win over A&M last week 50-7 (-17). A&M outgained UGA 274-260 in a 6 point loss the prior week. Against 4 common foes (Vandy, UF, Aub, A&M), UGA is +11 ppg & +71 ypg while LSU is +22 ppg, +221 ypg! LSU averages 187 ypg more than their foes allow. UGA holds foes 138 ypg below their average. The Tigers defense is coming off their best performance of the season, holding A&M to a season low 169 yards. QB Fromm has a 12-0 ratio in his L5 despite only completing 51%. LSU only allows 52% completions and are #14 in our Pass Efficiency Defense rankings. UGA will be missing their top 2 WR's for the 1H with Cager injured and Pickett suspended. UGA only allows 71 (2.5) rush ypg so LSU will have to rely on the arm of Joe Burrow, which shouldn't be an issue considering he's already topped 300 yards against our #16, #21 & #25 pass eff D's. The Tigers are the first team in SEC history to have a 4,000 yard passer, 1,000 yard rusher, and two 1,000 yard WR's. LSU is on a 10-3 ATS run vs FBS foes and Ed Orgeron is 21-9 ATS vs SEC foes. UGA is on a 20-9 ATS run vs SEC foes themselves but we are backing the Tigers and their prolific offense. **FORECAST: Lsu by 14**

OTHER SELECTIONS

MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - ALBERTSONS STADIUM - BOISE, ID

2★ Boise St over Hawai'i - Since 2001 Boise is 13-1 SU and 10-4 ATS against UH. Boise comes into this game with a 5 game win streak while UH has won 5 of their L6. Boise QB Bachmeier (1760, 64%, 9-4) has missed the last 4 games with an injury & his status here is unknown. Backup QB Henderson has started the L3 gms & has thrown for 732 yds (62%, 8-1) & is a capable starter should Bachmeier miss here. Boise frosh RB Holani is up to 912 rush yards this season (5.5 ypc) & UH's run defense gave up 203 rush yards last game vs Boise. But in UH's final 3 MW games they improved to allowing just 109 rush ypg, but did give up 414 rush yds last week to Army. UH is known for their run & shoot pass offense and averaged 349 yds over their F10 games, but in their L2 MW games they have put up just 236 pass ypg (359 pass yds vs Army LW) & QB's McDonald and Cordeiro have seen split time in their last 3 games. Boise did allow 325 pass yds to UH in their last meeting, but Boise's pass eff D is ranked #38 & UH has a TO margin of -13 (t-#124 in FBS). Boise can also get after the QB, as they lead the MW with 34 sacks, including 13.5 by DE Curtis Weaver. But UH's OL has allowed just 19 sacks in 552 pass attempts (3.4%). UH has improved their run game this season (164 ypg, 5.6 ypc in MW play) but faces a Boise run D that has allowed 102 ypg (3.5 ypc) over their L8 games. At home Boise holds foes to 109 ypg under their season average while UH gives up 22 ypg more than what MW foes average coming in. These teams faced 4 common MW foes and Boise was 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS & was +91 ypg while UH was 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS & was +65 ypg. Boise also has a large ST's edge in this game (#6 vs #76). Boise has won the L6 meetings both SU & ATS, winning by an average of 38 points and covering by an average of 16 points. On top of that Boise needs an impressive win to land the Group of 5 NY's Day Bowl Bid. **FORECAST: Boise by 21**

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BANK OF AMERICA STADIUM - CHARLOTTE, NC

2★ Clemson over Virginia - This is the first meeting since 2013 when Clemson won 59-10 (-18) on the road. Clemson enters on a 27 game winning streak. This is the Tigers 6th trip to the ACC Title game, and they've won the L4 (3-1 ATS) including last year when they handled Pitt 42-10 (-27) while holding the Panthers to a season low 199 yards. UVA ended a 15 year losing streak in the Commonwealth Cup last week to earn their first berth in the ACC Title game. The Hoos outscored the Hokies 19-3 in the 4Q including a late fumble recovery in the end zone to win 39-30 (+2). UVA is the 7th different team to win the ACC Coastal in 7Y. We've picked up both Early Bird Winners (Free on Mondays, 9-2 run, call 1-800-654-3448) and 3★ LPS winners on Clemson in each of their L2 wins, beating WF 52-3 (-34) and South Carolina 38-3 (-27). Since CU's 1 point win over NC, the Tigers have gone 6-0 SU/ATS vs FBS foes, winning by 42 ppg. The Tigers are +309 ypg and their defense is holding foes 178 ypg below their average (#1 in FBS). UVA has won 4 straight with 3 of those being decided late 4Q. The Hoos allowed 169 pass ypg in their F/8 but injuries in their secondary have taken a toll and they've allowed 302 ypg the last 4. QB Lawrence has gotten over his early season issues w/a 16-0 ratio in his L/5. QB Perkins has a 16-9 ratio and is also the Cavaliers leading rusher (687, 3.5) but Clemson counters with our #1 pass eff D and allow just 106 (2.9) rush ypg. Clemson is on a 16-2-1 ATS run vs ACC foes, and with UVA coming off an emotional win, we can't possibly go against the Tigers during this dominant run. **FORECAST: Clemson by 35**

OTHER GAMES

FRIDAY DECEMBER 6TH

PAC 12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LEVI'S STADIUM - SANTA CLARA, CA

Utah by 9 over Oregon - Utah is playing in second straight P12 Championship game while this will be the third for Oregon, but first since 2014. The Utes lost their lone title game appearance 10-3 (+5) vs Washington last year, while the Ducks are 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS. There was no meeting this year and Oregon is 7-3 SU, while Utah has covered four of the last five including three straight. The last matchup was in '18 and the Utes hosted and won 32-25 (-4). Utah enters having won eight in a row following their 45-15 (-28) blowout over Colorado. The Utes have held all 12 of their opponents under their season average in total offense and is #2 FBS on defense, holding foes to 171 ypg less than their average overall. The Ducks rebounded from a surprising loss at Arizona St two weeks ago with a 24-10 (-19) win last week vs Oregon St in the Civil War rivalry. Oregon was -15 yards and -3 TO's as QB Herbert threw for a season low 174 yards. There was eight common foes in the nine conference games and in P12 play Utah was +25 ppg and +216 ypg, while Oregon was +16 ppg and +84 ypg. The Utes will have the edge on defense, while the Ducks have the special teams advantage and the offenses are about even. Utah is on an 8-0 overall ATS run, while Oregon is 3-12 as a dog. The Utes have outgained every opponent this season, while the Ducks have been outgained in back-to-back games. Utah is hitting its stride and needs an impressive performance to make the Playoff and we expect them to give the committee some solid talking points after a win by over a touchdown.

SATURDAY DECEMBER 7TH

MAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - FORD FIELD - DETROIT, MI

Central Michigan by 10 over Miami, Oh - CM is 3-2 SU but 2-3 ATS vs MU s/12, with MU winning 3 straight ATS & 2 straight SI including their last meeting in '17 a 31-14 MU win as a 1' pt AD. In '09 Miami went 1-11 but had the biggest win turnaround in FBS history, winning the MAC Championship & their bowl to finish 10-4. Central Michigan is trying to equal that feat, as they were 1-11 last year & if they win this game & their bowl they will finish 10-4. Two weeks ago Miami after a win over BG, won the MAC East sitting at home as they watched Kent St's 4Q comeback that eliminated Buffalo from the MAC East race. At that time CM was in a 5 way race for the MAC West and coming into the final week needed NIU to upset WM (which they did), which allowed CM to claim the MAC West

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with a dominating 49-7 win over Toledo. Two wks ago Miami was lucky to survive with a 20-17 win over wireless Akron as a 31 pt HF. As they did not want to limp into this game, Miami LW had a 27-14 HT lead over Ball St, but after several players were injured in 1H, sat their starters all 2H & allowed 27 unanswered incl 21 in 4Q. While Miami played a slightly tougher schedule (#93-#119), that was weighted by playing Ohio St. While close on defense (CM#76-#80), CM has a big edge on offense (#58-#120). They are led by former Tenn transfer QB Quinten Dormandy (240 ypg, 67% 13-5), a RB duo who have a combined 2,009 rush yds (6.0 ypc) & 4 receivers with 450+ yds rec. Miami is led by QB Brett Gabbert (164 ypg, 54%, 10-8), 2 RB's who combined for 1,117 rush (4.9 ypc), with their TO WR having just 390 rec yds. The Chippewas was Achilles heal is TO's (-6) especially fumbles (15 lost) but Miami is just +2 TO for the ssn. Against their 6 common MAC foes Miami faced 4 at home & was 4-2 SU & 3-3 ATS. CM faced just 2 at home but was 4-2 su & 5-1 ATS. In those games the Redhaws outscored their foes by an average of 28-24 but were actually outgained by an avg 353-338 & were even TO's. The Chippewas outscored their foes by an avg 35-29 & outgained them by an average of 497-372 & were +2 TO's. We look for CM offense to be the difference here as they look to claim their first MAC Championship since 2009.

SUN BELT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - KIDD-BREWSTER STADIUM - BOONE, NC

APPALACHIAN ST by 4 over Louisiana - Rematch of last season's SBC title game where App (-17) led 17-16 late 3Q before outscoring ULL 13-3 the rest of the way & winning the inaugural SBC Title Game 30-19. Earlier this ssn App travelled to ULL as underdogs (+1) and held them to 269 yards below their season average in a 17-7 win. App has been largely dominant under first year HC Drinkwitz, going 11-1 SU/8-4 ATS & getting 2 road wins over P5 teams (N.Car & S.Car). App's offense is led by QB Thomas (2427, 64%, 24-6) and RB Evans (1250, 5.8, 16 TD) & have averaged 470 yards and 39 points in SBC play this season, but WR Sutton (601, 7 td) is OFY (ACL). But ULL's pass eff D is ranked #29 & they held App to 147 pass yards earlier this season. Their defense has also been lights out this season, allowing SBC foes just 278 ypg & holding them to 139 ypg under their season average. ULL enters this game with the #6 rush offense in the FBS (274 ypg, 6.6 ypc) led by RB's Mitchell (998, 5.8, 14 TD), Calais (827, 8.4, 6 TD), and Ragas (814, 7.3, 12 TD). QB Lewis has also done a solid job this season, throwing for 2,403 yards (65%, 20-4), but App's pass eff D ranks #28. ULL gave up 240 rush yards LW to ULM and 3 weeks ago allowed Sala to run for 351 yards. ULL must now face an App run game that has put up 238 ypg in SBC play. Against 6 common SBC foes App is 5-1 SU/3-3 ATS & are +203 ypg, +24 ppg while ULL is 6-0 SU/4-2 ATS & are +141 ypg, +24 ppg, so they are both beating inferior teams by a significant margin. App is 7-0 SU in this series, but ULL is 3-0-1 ATS as a road SBC dog under HC Napier & were clearly looking ahead to this game, nearly losing to rival ULM as 19' point chalk. The home team in this series is just 1-6 ATS and ULL has kept these games close the L2Y and we see that happening again, with App's superior defense (#20 vs #50) likely being the difference in this game.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - AT&T STADIUM - ARLINGTON, TX

Oklahoma by 10 over Baylor - This is Oklahoma's 11th B12 Title game appearance (9-1 SU/7-2-1 ATS) and Baylor's first. In their prior meeting three weeks ago on November 16th, the Bears hosted and led 31-10 at the half with a 250-131 yard edge. It was all Sooners in the second half as they tied the game with 5:25 left and made the game-winning 31 yard fg with 1:45 remaining and won 34-31 (-10). Oklahoma allowed just 57 total yards in the second half. Since that setback that saw their perfect season end, Baylor has won back-to-back games and enters off arguably its most impressive performance of the season. In the 61-6 (-14) blowout at Kansas last week the Bears finished with a 227 yard edge & were +5 TO's. The Sooners meanwhile, enter on a four game winning streak following their 34-16 (-13) Bedlam win. Oklahoma held their arch rival to 144 yards below their average and finished with a 450-335 yard edge. In this series the Sooners have won 5 in a row & is 3-2 ATS. Every B12 team plays one another in the regular season and Oklahoma was +14 ppg & +197 ypg in conference action, while Baylor finished +13 ppg & +45 ypg. While the Sooners are #3 FBS on offense averaging 146 ypg more than their opponents allow, it's the defense that has turned heads. Just one year after finishing #92 in the FBS, Oklahoma is #15 this year, holding opponents to 89 ypg below their average. Over their last three games (including Baylor), the Sooners are holding foes to 172 ypg below their average! Turnovers played a major role in Oklahoma having to come from behind in the prior meeting and once they fixed those issues it was all Sooners. Oklahoma's players are used to these pressure situations and in their last two B12 Title games have won by an average of 18 ppg. We'll call for Oklahoma to give the Playoff committee something to think about after winning their Conference Championship game by double-digits. Boomer Sooner.

CUSA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - FAU STADIUM - BOCA RATON, FL

FAU by 4 over Uab - First meeting between two of CUSA's top coaches, Bill Clark vs Lane Kiffin. These two met last in 2013, FAU won 37-23 (+3). UAB is playing in their 2nd consecutive CUSA Title gm. Last year they avenged a 24 point loss at Middle Tenn the week prior and won 27-25 (+1). FAU won their first CUSA Title the year prior, crushing N Texas 41-17 (-11'). The Blazers have won every home game they've played since their rebirth in '17 (18-0 SU/14-3-1 ATS) but they haven't fared nearly as well on the road, going 9-10 SU/10-9 ATS. We did pick up a Power Sweep 3★ winner LW in the Blazers 26-21 (-3) win over N Texas. RB Brown was finally healthy and rushed for 111. FAU has won their L5 games, including a 34-17 (-9) win over Southern Miss LW, though they did finish with their lowest yards since the opener at 300. All 9 of FAU's wins have come by DD's. UAB is +94 ypg but only +27 ypg on the road. FAU is +45 ypg and +30 ypg at home and they've played the tougher schedule (#101 vs #130). The Owls average 53 ypg more than their foes allow (#31 in FBS). UAB holds foes 86 ypg below their average (#16 in FBS). Against 4 common foes (SM, UTSA, ODU, WKU) UAB is 2-2 SU/ATS, -0.3 ppg & +120 ypg, FAU is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS, +20 ppg & +99 ypg. UAB's road struggles have us calling for FAU to win, but Bill Clark is 23-9 ATS vs CUSA foes and they won this game last year on the road so we will call for UAB to keep it within a touchdown.

AAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LIBERTY BOWL MEMORIAL STADIUM - MEMPHIS, TN

MEMPHIS by 14 over Cincinnati - This is a direct rematch as Memphis beat Cincinnati 34-24 (-12) last week in this very location. Bearcats QB Ridder did not play (shoulder, CS) and the Tigers never trailed, but did finish with just a 432-407 yard edge. Backup QB Bryant made his first career start and completed 63% but did have a 1-2 ratio. Memphis has now won four in a row SU in the series, but Cincinnati has covered eight of the L10 and the visitor is on a 5-0 ATS run. The Tigers are playing in their third straight AAC Championship game, but hosting it for the first time, while this is the Bearcats first appearance. UM is +83 ypg in AAC play and +93 ypg at home, while Cincinnati is -40 ypg in AAC play and -55 ypg away. Against four common foes (Temple/Tulsa/Hou/USF) the Tigers are 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS, +14 ppg and +154 ypg, while the Bearcats are 4-0 SU/1-3 ATS, +8 ppg and -88 ypg. Memphis has the edge on offense and special teams, while the defenses are about even. The Tigers are 12-2 ATS hosting AAC opponents and on a 20-7 overall ATS run. Cincinnati has been outgained in seven of their last eight games including three straight. Even if QB Ridder returns for this game, he still won't be 100%. We don't see much difference in the outcome of last weeks game and the way this weeks game will finish. Memphis appears to be the best Group of Five team in the nation and a win here will propel them into a coveted NYD Bowl!

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LUCAS OIL STADIUM - INDIANAPOLIS, IN

Ohio State by 28 over Wisconsin - The B10 Title game began in 2011 and Ohio St is making its fifth appearance (3-1 SU/ATS) while Wisconsin is appearing for a conference high sixth time (2-3 SU/1-4 ATS). The Buckeyes have won back-to-back B10 Championship games, while this will be the Badgers third appearance in the last four years. This is a rematch from the last weekend in October when Ohio St hosted and won 38-7 (-14). The Badgers trailed just 10-0 at the half, but was dominated in the second half and for the game was held to season lows in first downs (9) and total yards (191). The Buckeyes are on a 10-1 SU/9-2 ATS run in the series! Both enter off huge rivalry games. Ohio St dominated Michigan, winning 56-27 (-9) and the 577 total yards was the most allowed by the Wolverines this season. Wisconsin was in a must win situation to reach the title game and avenged their '18 defeat by recapturing Paul Bunyan's Axe after travelling to Minnesota and winning 38-17 (-3). The Badgers allowed 75 of the 372 yards during the Gophers final scoring drive mid 4Q. Against four common foes (Nebraska/Mich St/NW/Michigan) Ohio St is +36 ppg and +264 ypg, while Wisconsin was +21 ppg and +105 ypg. The Buckeyes have the edge in all three phases as they continue to look like the most complete in the nation this year. Ohio St is #1 FBS on offense, averaging 190 ypg more than their opponents allow and is #3 on defense, holding foes to 156 ypg less than their average. The Buckeyes also have our #24 ranked special teams unit. Wisconsin allowed a season high five sacks in the first meeting and Chase Young will be salivating after being held without a sack last week. Ohio St is on an 11-4 overall ATS run, while the Badgers have failed to cover four of their last six games. We'll call for the Buckeyes dominance to continue as they advance to the Playoff after another blowout victory.

4★ CLEVELAND over Cincinnati - Following a disappointing loss LW in Heinz Field where they were held to just 13 pts & 279 yds (3★ LP Winner on Under 39.5!), the Browns return home needing to win out to have any chance of grabbing the final WC spot in the AFC (likely favored in 3 of L/4 gms TY). The Bengals meanwhile earned their 1st victory of the ssn by holding the Jets to just 6 pts & 271 yds in the 16 pt victory. In their 2 matchups of a yr ago, CLE picked up 35-20 & 26-18 victories for their first series sweep in 16 seasons. With the Browns having covered 7 of their L/10 inside of the AFC North coming into this matchup and outscoring their L/2 home opponents by 15 ppg, we have no problem laying the spread here as they look to rebound. **FORECAST: CLEVELAND by 17**
3★ OAKLAND over Tennessee - Huge matchup in the AFC for one of the 2 WC spots as the Titans head to the Bay Area to take on the Raiders. The Titans earned a key DIV victory LW on the road against the Colts despite a 391-292 yd deficit. The Raiders meanwhile have been outscored by a 74-12 margin the past 2 weeks in losses to the Jets & Chiefs. In their season-opening matchup back in '17, the Raiders went into Nashville as a 2' pt dog and came out with a 26-16 upset victory (QB Carr 22-32 for 262 yds & 2 TD's). While the Titans would love to return the favor this time around, we like the Raiders to get the job done here inside of the "Black Hole" where they've covered 6 of the past 8 overall. **FORECAST: OAKLAND by 6**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Indianapolis over TAMPA BAY - Following a shocking DIV home loss LW where TEN returned IND's late blocked FG at 63 yds for the go-ahead TD, the Colts head into non-conf play for each of the next 3 weeks. The Bucs meanwhile picked up an easy road win LW in JAX (315-242 yd edge) for their 2nd straight cover after 6th consec ATS defeats. In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Colts (-3) overcame a 12-6 HT deficit by holding the Bucs scoreless in the final 2 quarters of the 13 pt win. With the Colts having covered 12 of their last 17 meetings against the NFC heading into this matchup including a 3 pt home victory over ATL back in Wk 3, we have no problem siding with them here (TB 4-16 ATS as a HF). **FORECAST: Indianapolis by 4**

OTHER PLAYS

Dallas at CHICAGO - Thursday - Following a 26-15 (-7) defeat against the Bills on Thanksgiving where we picked up a 3★ LP Winner on "Under 47", the Cowboys head to the "Windy City" to take on a Bears squad that also came out victorious last Thur against the Lions behind a 338 yd, 3 TD effort from QB Trubisky. In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Cowboys (-6) earned a 14 pt home victory over the Bears in a game that they led 24-3 at HT (DAL 447-390 yd edge). With DAL needing a win here to maintain their lead in the NFC East, it will be interesting to see if the Bears can add to their already impressive 10-5 ATS mark inside of Soldier Field. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Baltimore by 3 over BUFFALO - After a narrow home win against the 49ers a week ago where they connected on a GW 49-yd FG as time expired, the Ravens head back on the road to take on a Bills team that delivered the 26-15 (+7) upset of the Cowboys despite FD (32-22) and yard (426-356) deficits. In their season-opening matchup a year ago, the Ravens (-7) finished with 26-10 FD & 369-153 yd edges in the easy 47-3 blowout victory. With both teams well within range of making playoff appearances this ssn, we're cutting off our lean for the visitor at just a FG as the Bills have some extra rest after playing on Thanksgiving while the Ravens have a Thur night matchup on deck.

GREEN BAY by 17 over Washington - Following another embarrassing trip to California the week prior against the 49ers, the Packers got back into the win column against the Giants with QB Rodgers throwing for 4 TD's. The Redskins meanwhile stretched their winning streak to 2 in a row with a surprising upset victory over the Panthers in Charlotte (248-65 yd rushing edge). In their Wk 3 matchup a year ago, the Redskins (+2) jumped out to a 28-10 HT lead in the eventual 14 pt victory. While WAS has actually won and covered 3 of the L/4 overall in this series dating back to '10, we'll call for GB to get the easy win in Lambeau this time around as not only have they gone 28-15-2 ATS as a NDIV HF, but the Redskins have also failed to cover 7 of their past 11 games overall.

HOUSTON by 12 over Denver - While it's been another long season for the Broncos fanbase, they did pick up the season sweep of the Chargers a week ago at home with QB Lock (18-28 for 134 yds & 2-1 ratio) earning his 1st career start. The Texans meanwhile are back at home for a 3rd straight week following a 3 pt win over DIV rival IND and 6 pt victory against the Patriots (QB Watson 4 tL TD's). In HOU's midseason trip to "Mile High" a year ago, the Broncos would miss a 51-yd FG as time expired in the 19-17 defeat (DEN 348-290 yd edge). With the Texans needing a win here to stay atop the AFC South and DEN's 4-11 ATS mark as a NDIV AD, we have no problem backing the home team in this one (HOU 12-6 ATS as a NDIV HF) as they take on a rookie QB making his very first road start.

NEW ORLEANS by 3 over San Francisco - Potential battle for the #1 seed in the NFC playoff picture as the 49ers (10-2) head into the Superdome to take on the 10-2 Saints. The 49ers do come in following a road loss LW in BAL against the Ravens who connected on a 49-yd FG as time expired (SF 331-283 yd edge). The Saints meanwhile picked up their 3rd consec victory on Thanksgiving Night against the Falcons to already clinch the NFC South crown. In their most recent meeting back in '16, the Saints went to the Bay Area as 4' pt chalk and came away with an 18 pt victory (game featured 64 pts & 1,057 tL yds). While the Saints have covered 8 of their L/10 coming into this matchup, a FG lean is all that we can offer up as SF continues to impress us on both sides of the ball with the league's #2 scoring offense (29.1 ppg) and #2 scoring defense (15.3 ypg).

ATLANTA by 6 over Carolina - After a shocking 29-21 home loss LW to the Redskins (-10) to all but end their hopes for the final WC berth, the Panthers head to ATL seeking revenge following a 29-3 clubbing just 3 weeks ago in Charlotte where QB Allen was forced into 4 int's while being sacked on 5 occasions. The Falcons meanwhile are back at home for a 3rd straight week (5th consec DIV matchup) following a Thanksgiving contest against the Saints where QB Ryan was sacked 9 times in the 26-18 defeat. While this marks the final away contest for the Panthers TY, LW's loss along with the prior matchup has us leaning with the home team on extra rest.

MINNESOTA by 17 over Detroit - Following their 7th straight ATS loss LW at home on Thanksgiving against the Bears (5th consec SU defeat) where 3rd string QB Blough earned his 1st career start (280 yds, 2-1 ratio), the Lions head to MIN in search of their 3rd win in Minneapolis in 4 years. That lone defeat did come a year ago however as the Vikings held the Lions to just a trio of FG's in the 24-9 win. While their earlier meeting in '19 featured a bit more scoring, the result was the same with MIN picking up the 42-30 road victory as 2' pt chalk (503-433 yd edge). With DET continuing to deal with a plethora of injuries on both sides of the ball coming in along with MIN's impressive 22-7-1 ATS mark as a HF, a 17 pt lean seems about right this time around.

NY JETS by 3 over Miami - It appears to be revenge time for the hometown Jets in this one as they look to even up the season series at one apiece after giving the Dolphins their 1st win of the '19 campaign back in Wk 10. The Dolphins claimed another home upset victory LW against the Eagles as QB Fitzpatrick threw for 365 yds & 3 TD's in the 37-31 win. The Jets on the other hand saw their 3-gm winning streak snapped in surprising fashion a week ago against winless CIN who held NY to just 6 pts & 271 yds (Jets scored 34 pts in each of prior 3 contests!). While MIA has failed to cover 10 of their L/13 overall when listed as a DIV AD, we find it difficult to lean with the Jets by more than a FG (NYJ 2-9 ATS vs AFC East foes incl a 4-1-10 upset loss LY at home against BUF as 7 pt chalk).

LA Chargers by 4 over JACKSONVILLE - The Chargers head to JAX following their 8th loss of the ssn (all by 7 pts or less) LW in DEN. The Jaguars meanwhile dropped a home matchup against the Bucs who jumped out to a 25-0 HT lead in the 17 pt victory (QB Foles benched for Minshew in 2H). In their most recent matchup back in '17, the Jags connected on a 34-yd FG w/03 left and a 30-yd FG in OT for the 20-17 victory (5' pt chalk). With the Chargers winning the 6 previous meetings in this series (7-0 ATS run) by 19 ppg, we'll go ahead and give them the small lean here as JAX doesn't get the advantage of playing them early in the day with a 4:05pm scheduled kickoff.

NEW ENGLAND by 3 over Kansas City - Rematch of LY's AFC Championship Game where NE picked up a 37-31 victory with dominating FD (36-18) and yard (524-290) edges. KC returned from their bye a week ago with an easy win over the Raiders (outgained 332-259, +3TO's) to stretch their lead in the DIV to 2 games. The Patriots meanwhile dropped a 28-22 contest in HOU to slip back to the #2 spot in the AFC behind BAL. While NE is an outstanding 20-9 ATS as a HF coming in, a FG lean is all that we can offer up here as the Chiefs are on a 9-1 ATS as an AD including a pair of covers in Foxboro (outright upset in '17, +8).

ARIZONA by 1 over Pittsburgh - Following a 7 pt home win over rival CLE where we picked up a 3★ LP Winner on the "Under 39.5", the Steelers head to the desert for a rematch of SB XLIII, a game that saw PIT escape with a 27-23 victory. The Cardinals had no answer for the Rams in their return from bye LW at home as they were outgained 549-198 in the 27 pt defeat. In their last regular season meeting back in '15, the Steelers (+4, QB Roethlisberger out) picked up a 25-13 upset win in Heinz Field thanks to a 3-0 TO edge (ARZ 469-310 yd edge). While the Cardinals failed to cover 11 of 16 matchups against the AFC heading into '19, they're a perfect 2-0 ATS TY including an outright upset of the Bengals back in Wk 5. We'll call for them to continue that recent run in this one with PIT taking a hit in their attempt for the final WC spot in the AFC.

Seattle at LA RAMS - SNF - This marks the 3rd primetime HG in a 4-wk span for the Rams who return from the desert (QB Goff 424 yds & 2 TD's in 27 pt win) sitting 1.5 games back of the final WC spot in the NFC. The Seahawks meanwhile head South on short rest following a MNF home tilt against the Vikings. In their Wk 5 meeting earlier TY on Thur Night, the Seahawks overcame a 5 pt deficit in the 4Q to win 30-29 (Rams 477-429 yd edge, missed a 44-yd FG w/:11 left). While SEA has dropped 4 of their L/5 road trips to take on the Rams including a 36-31 defeat a season ago, keep in mind that they're a perfect 6-0 SU on the road so far TY (5-1 ATS) with a 7 pt avg MOV. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

NY Giants at PHILADELPHIA - MNF - After being held to 19 total points the prior 2 weeks in losses to the Patriots and Seahawks, the Eagles saw their offense get back on track LW in South Beach against the Dolphins with 31 pts. Unfortunately, their defense was a no-show as MIA put up 37 pts & 409 yds in the 6 pt upset victory. The Giants meanwhile had plenty of issues in their home meeting with the Packers in Wk 13 as QB Jones threw 3 int's in the 18 pt defeat. In their trip to PHI as ssn ago, the Giants saw their losing streak to the Eagles extend to 5 in a row (GW 43-yd FG w/:22 left) despite finishing with a 402-341 yd edge. While we'll go ahead and call for PHI to continue their winning ways against their DIV rival once again, it's also worth mentioning that they've failed to cover 9 of their L/13 when listed as a HF.
