First mtg. HC Clawson has WF playing a bowl for the 5th straight year, their longest streak in school history. The Deacons have won 3 of the L/4 bowls (2-1-1 ATS) but did lose LY in the Pinstripe Bowl. WF has won 2 previous trips here when it was known as the Meineke Car Care & Belk Bowl. UW is making their first trip to this bowl. HC Chryst is 4-1 SU/ATS in bowls but lost LY's Rose Bowl.

UW had 15 starters returning in '20 and while they did lose QB Coan due to inj, bkp QB Mertz was a higher rated recruit out of HS. The Badgers won their opener over IL 45-7 (-19') then after they had 2 gms ppg due to Covid they blew out Mich 49-11 (-6'). The offense went into hibernation over the next 3 gms as they only scored 20 pt points in losses to NW, Ind & Iowa. Their top RB was out against Minn & they only won 20-17 (-12') in OT. The Badgers avg 359 ypg and are +95 ypg despite only being 3-3. Their defense is holding foes 120 ypg below their avg. The Badgers only avg 314 ypg in their L/4 and just 127 (3.5) rush.

WF only had 11 starters returning but HC Clawson always gets the best of his teams and they did get QB Hartman back, who beat out Jamie Newman in '18. WF lost their first 2 games but kept it closer than expected vs Clem & only lost by a fg at NCST. The Deacons won 4 straight including outright upsets over UVA & VT. They put up 53 pts & 606 yds but lost by 6 pts at NCar then only trailed by a td 4Q vs Lville before allowing 17 unanswered for a deceiving 24 pt loss. WF finished -51 ypg vs FBS foes. The Deacons allowed 37 ypg more than their foes avg'd and suffered a big loss when DE Basham (11 sks) opted out of the bowl. QB Hartman has a 10-1 ratio and WF put up 14 ypg more than their foes allow on avg.

UW has an edge on DEF but WF has the edge on OFF and ST. WF will have a small home field edge and UW was missing key plyrs at RB & WR down the stretch so we think WF keeps it within a fg.

FORECAST: WAKE FOREST (+) RATING: 2★

The only prior meeting was in the '09 BCS title game, where UF took down OU 24-14 to win their 2nd nat'l title in 3 years. UF is in a bowl for a 3rd straight ssn under HC Mullen & overall he is 7-2 SU (4-5 ATS) in bowls. OU HC Riley is 0-3 SU (1-2 ATS) in bowls, but all 3 games were CFP semifinal gms.

UF brought back 12 str's from their 11-2 tm in '19. UF started the ssn with DD wins over Miss & SCar but then lost by 3 at Tex A&M. UF got back on track with 6 straight wins all by DD's incl a 44-28 win vs UGA. With the SEC East locked up UF slipped up vs LSU, by 3 pts (GW 57-yd FG for LSU w/ 23 sec). In the SEC title gm UF trailed Bama 35-17 but made a strong comeback and fell 52-46. Trask led the FBS in pass yds & the OFF put up 100 ypg more than their foes all'd while the OL all'd 19 sks in 429 att but 9 sks were in the L/2 gms. Star TE Pitts will not play here. UF's DEF struggled at times (605 all'd vs Bama) & their pass D is #70 but did collect 32 sks.

OU brought back 16 str's from their 12-2 team LY, but did have a hole at QB after losing their 3rd QB in 3 years to the NFL. After winning big vs an FCS tm OU dropped their first 2 B12 games to Kan St & ISU as r/r QB Rattler had 4 int's. OU rebounded with a 40T win over rival Tex & then won at TCU 33-14 before blowing out both TTech and Kansas by a comb'd score of 124-37. After a bye OU thumped rival OSU 41-13 before "only" beating Bay by 13 & their gm vs WVU was canceled. OU then won 27-21 over ISU to win their 6th straight B12 title. After throwing 5 int's in his first 3 B12 gms Rattler got better, throwing just 2 int's in the L/6 gms & RB Stevenson re'd to add to the run gm. OU's DEF was a strength as they all'd 335 ypg & held foes to 38 ypg below their ssn avg while collecting 36 sks.

UF could have more players opt out & while both OFF's are strong, OU has the better DEF that can slow UF's OFF down. OU is on a 6-1 ATS run & we agree w/ the checklist that OU is the better team.

First meeting. Miss St is playing in this bowl for the 1st time & since 1999 are 9-4 SU/7-6 ATS in bowl games. Miss St HC Leach is 7-8 SU in bowl games but is only 4-11 ATS. Tulsa makes their 3rd trip to this bowl & lost their prior trips here in '11 vs BYU (24-21) and in '06 vs Utah (25-13). Tulsa is back in a bowl for the 1st time since '16 & HC Montgomery is 2-0 ATS in bowls at Tulsa.

Miss St brought back 11 st's for the '20 ssn but hired Mike Leach as their new HC and they got in zero spring practices. MSU upset LSU in the opener (623 pass yds) but MSU quickly took a step back as they lost the next 4 gms & only avg'd 7 pts. MSU got win #2 vs Vandy despite getting outgained 478-204 (+5 TO's) but then lost 3 in row before getting a win vs Mizzou the end the ssn. While the OFF avg'd 348 yds QB Rogers provided a spark after becoming the starter as he avg'd 304 pass ypg in the L/5 gms & WR Walley finished the ssn with 4 straight 100-yd gms. MSU's DEF did hold foes to 46 ypg & gave up just 125 rush ypg (3.6) on the ssn.

Tulsa entered '20 off a 4-8 ssn but were bringing back 13 st's. Before their gm vs Okla St it was announced RB Brooks (1046, 4.6 in '19) would be OFY but TU nearly upset Okla St, losing 16-7. TU then would hold UCF to 3 pts in 2H and pulled the outright upset 34-26. After a blowout win at USF the Hurricane won a close gm vs ECU (blown call went in TU's favor). Against SMU they came back from a 24-7 HT deficit to win 28-24 & then vs Tulane came back to tie the gm on a hail mary & then won in 2OT on a pick-6. They beat Navy in the ssn finale before losing by 3 to Cincy in the AAC title game. While TU's OFF was solid this ssn (406 ypg/27 ppg), their DEF was their strength, holding foes to 97 ypg under their ssn avg & collected 19 sks, but AAC DPOY Collins has opted out of this gm.

Tulsa is a talented team, but seeing MSU as a dog to a G5 school has up thinking they come out motivated to make a statement.

Army is 2-1 all-time vs WV but these 2 haven't met since 1961. Army replaced Tenn who was originally scheduled to play here but had to back out due to Covid. The Black Knights are 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in bowls under HC Monken but they did not go bowling LY. HC Brown went 3-0 SU/ATS in bowls at Troy and is coaching his first bowl at WV. The Mountaineers are 0-2 in the Liberty Bowl, losing most recently in 2014 vs A&M.

WV only won 5 gms in '19 but they had 14 starters back in Neal Brown's 2nd year so we expected improvement. The Mountaineers lost by 2 td's at OKSt but held a +11 yd edge. We won our free 5★ on WV's 27-21 (+1) win over Baylor. They suffered a surprising loss at TxFech despite a +90 yd edge, had dominant wins over Kansas St (37-10) and TCU (24-6), nearly upset Texas on the road but finished with a 42-6 (+6) loss against a motivated Iowa St tm. WV only finished 5-4 but was +125 ypg and their defense held foes to 297 ypg and 85 ypg below their foes avg. The DiLine is stout, led by the Stills brothers, allowing just 126 (3.6).

Army had 12 starters back in '20. We won our very first star rated play this year on the Black Knights 42-0 (-3) win over MT. Army went 6-1 to start the ssn but 3 of their wins came over FCS foes. They got beat 38-12 (+3) at Tulane then won their last 3 games including wins over Navy & Army to win the Commander in Chief trophy. The Black Knights avg 325 ypg and are +54 ypg. Their defense holds foes to 271 ypg and 116 ypg below their avg.

WV has a stout DEF and a significant edge on offense. WV DC Koenning was DC at Troy and faced GSthrn's option each year. Army is only #87 in our Pass D rankings and they've faced a steady diet of run heavy/opton teams for the last 2 months. The Black Knights are in an unprecedented situation, coming off B2B wins over Academy rivals and WV is far better than their record indicates.

These old Southwest Conference foes have met 70 times, but have only met 2 times since 1991. With no requirements for bowl tms this ssn Ark was able to slide in at 3-7 & are in a bowl for the 1st time since '16's Belk Bowl. TCU HC Patterson is in a bowl for the 17th time here & has gone 11-5 SU/7-8-1 ATS so he has the huge coaching edge over Ark's 1st year HC.

Arkansas brought back 14 st'rs from LY's 2-10 team, but had a new HC in Sam Pittman & they did not get any spring practices in. Ark did lead UGA 7-5 at HT but lost 37-10, then won at Miss St despite getting outgained by 125 yds (+2 TO's). Ark then lost at Aub by 2 (blown call 4Q) before winning vs Ole Miss by 12 then lost at A&M by just 11 pts. After an 11-pt win vs Tenn (down 13-0 HT) Ark lost their last 4 gms (63-35 vs UF, 52-3 vs Bama) to finish 3-7. Transfer QB Franks did hit 69% & the OFF hit over 400 yds in 6 gms but the OL struggled to open up holes at times & all'd 34 sks incl 8 to Bama. The DEF all'd 527 ypg/48 ppg in their L/4 and all'd foes to gain 14 ypg above their ssn avg with just 14 sks.

TCU brought back 12 st'rs incl QB Duggan & their top 3 tkl'rs. TCU lost the opener to ISU but then upset Tex on the road. TCU dropped their next 2 gms to KSt (342-289) and OU but then rebounded to win their next 2 gms vs BU and TTech. After a 24-6 loss to WVU, TCU would win their L/3 gms & finished the ssn on a 5-1 ATS run. Duggan led the team in rushing & TCU avg'd 215 rush yds (5.2). TCU's strength is their DEF led by their strong DLine and stout pass DEF (#20) as they held foes to 42 ypg under their ssn avg & collected 26 sks led by DE Mathis (9 sks).

TCU has a solid OFF (#43) and we expect them to put up points against an Ark DEF that struggled the L/4 gms. TCU does have a talented DEF, but we think Ark's OFF (#33) can put up enough to push the score over the total.

FORECAST: OVER **RATING: 2★**

These tms have met 2 times previous but the last mtg was in 1976! UGA makes their 6th trip to the Peach Bowl & their last appearance was in the nat'l title gm in '17. UGA HC Smart is 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS in bowl games here. Cincy makes their 1st trip to the Peach Bowl & they are 2-0 SU (1-1 ATS) in bowls under Fickell.

Cincy got to 11 wins LY under HC Fickell & ret'd 15 st'rs incl 9 on defense & QB Ridder. After an easy win vs an FCS mt Cincy beat Army 24-10 and won by 21 pts vs USF despite on gaining 332 yds. At 3-0 Cincy began to pour it on as in their next 4 gms they went 4-0, winning by 34 ppg & outgaining SMU,Mem,HOU,ECU by 232 ypg. This set up a marquee matchup at UCF & Cincy would win 36-33 & held UCF to 255 yds under their ssn avg. In the AAC title game Cincy put up 92 yds above what Tulsa's DEF was all'g & they won by a FG. QB Ridder hit 67% (16-6 ratio) & also ran for 526 (7.9, 11 td). The strong Cincy DEF held foes to 139 ypg under their season avg (#1) with 27 sks & their pass DEF ranks #2 in the FBS.

UGA brought back just 11 st'rs (only 3 on OFF) from LY. Transfer QB Newman was supposed to start but he opted out leaving a former walk-on as the starter. UGA won their F/3 gms all by 21+ pts but then were blown out by Bama (414-564, -2 TO's). After a win vs UK, UGA lost to Florida 44-28 (277-571). The switch was flipped when QB Daniels took over. In UGA's L/3 gms he threw for 839 yds (67%, 9-1) & The OFF avg'd 498 yds/42 pts after the pass OFF avg'd 209 yds the F/6 gms. Aside from the UF & Bama gms the DEF gave up 253 ypg/13 ppg and they only all'd 69 rush ypg (2.3).

UGA does have a huge "home field" edge as they have played at this stadium several times & only travel 73 miles while Cincy has to travel much further & the UGA fans will be the majority of the limited crowd. Cincy has a strong DEF but we think the new-look UGA OFF & their stout DEF will overpower the Bearcats

FORECAST: GEORGIA **RATING: 3★**

These 2 met in the 2010 Outback Bowl with Aub pulling out a 38-35 (-9') win. The Tigers are in a bowl for the 8th straight year but that wasn't enough to help Gus Malzahn keep his job. Kevin Steele, who never reached a bowl during his time as HC at Baylor ('99-'02) takes over as Interim HC. NW returns to a bowl after missing LY. HC Fitzgerald is 4-5 SU/6-3 ATS in bowls. Aub is 3-2 SU at the Citrus Bowl with their last appearance in 2006 while NW lost their only trip here against Peyton Manning's Vols in 1997.

Aub lost most of their OL and Dline and only had 10 returning starters in '20. The Tigers split their F/4 gms, with extremely fortunate wins vs KY (-60 yds) & Ark. Aub had another fortunate win over Ole Miss that sparked a 3 gm winning streak before they were crushed by Bama & beat worse than the score indicated by A&M. They only led 6-3 at half but beat Miss St 24-10 then HC Malzahn was let go. Aub is -16 ypg on the ssn and their offense avg 28 ypg less than their foes allow. RB Bigsby has 834 (6.0) and after being banged up for 3 gms he was 100% & ran for 192 yds vs Miss St.

NW went just 3-9 in '19 despite only allowing 24 ppg & 336 ypg. They had 17 starters back and added Indiana transfer QB Ramsey so we felt they'd be vastly improved. We were all over the 'Cats during their 5 game win streak to start the ssn, picking up 3 LPS winners, 2 Underdog POW Power Sweep winners & a 4★ on these pages! They were #8 in the Playoff Poll but fell behind 17-0 at Mich St in their first loss. They crushed IL then only lost by 12 pts vs OSU in the B10 Title gm. NW is +10 ypg and holds foes 64 ypg below their average.

QB Nix only has a 12-12 ratio away from home and NW brings our #1 pass D that held OSU's Fields to 114 pass yds & 2 ints. NW has a huge coaching edge and we're sure not sure how motivated Aub will be after their coach was fired. The checklist on the left says Aub keeps this close but we like NW to win by more than a fg.

1st mtg. Indiana has lost their last 3 bowl trips by just 6 total points including LY when they blew a 13 pt lead in the last 5 minutes and lost by 1 pt vs Tenn. HC Kiffin is only coaching his 2nd bowl (1-0 SU/ATS). This is the Rebels first bowl since 2015. Both teams are making their first trip to the Outback Bowl.

Lane Kiffin took over a UM program that had 13 st's back but only won 9 gms the last 2Y. The Rebels lost their opener 51-35 (+14) vs FL but they did put up 613 yds and threw an int at the UF14 & was SOD at the UF19. UM beat KY 42-41 (+6) thanks to a missed PAT in OT then put up 48 pts and 647 yds in a 15 pt loss vs Bama. They were upset 33-21 (-1) at Ark thanks to 7 TO's. The Rebels lost by a td vs Aub for their 3rd straight loss. UM won 3 straight vs Vandy, SCar & Miss St. They did trail the Gamecocks 42-38 before scoring the last 3 td's. WR Moore and TE Yeboah opted out prior to their finale but they still put up 48 pts in a 5 pt loss at LSU. The Rebels avg 563 ypg and are +22 ypg but their -10 TO ratio and a pass D that ranks dead last in the FBS are a big reason they've lost 5 gms. RB Ealy and WR Sanders are both ? due to injuries suffered vs LSU.

This was clearly HC Allen's best team at IU entering 20 with 17 starters back from a 7 win team. The Hoosiers beat Penn St in OT despite getting out'd 488-211. That win sparked a 4-0 start for the Hoosiers. They trailed 35-7 at OSU but fought back & only lost by 7. Their 16 pt win vs MD was costly with QB Penix going OFY w/a knee injury. QB Tuttle stepped in and IU only had 217 yds but beat Wisc 14-6 (+13). IU avg 358 ypg but hit -4 ypg and their OFF has put up 25 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. Their DEF is stout, with our #9 pass D ranking (57%, 9-11) but this is the best OFF they've faced.

UM has an explosive OFF and even with the opt outs they are still explosive. IU is missing their starting QB but has a huge edge on DEF. This is a tough call with lots of questions so we'll take the pts.

First meeting. UO is in the Fiesta bowl for a 4th time (lost '11 national title game here) while ISU is here for the 1st time. UO has a pair of 1-pt bowl wins under HC Cristobal (1-1 ATS) incl LY's 28-27 Rose Bowl win (+3) vs Wisc. ISU is in a bowl for a 4th straight ssn under Campbell & they are 1-2 SU/2-1 ATS & lost to NDame LY.

UO was off a 12-2 ssn in '19 but lost QB Herbert to the NFL & had just 12 st's back. The Ducks ssn began with 2 DD wins despite being -5 TO's. UO then won by 3 vs UCLA (+3 TO's) but dropped their rivalry gm vs OSU as they gave up the GW TD w/ 33 sec left (did lead 31-19 3Q). UO then lost at Cal 21-17 despite outgaining them (368-271, -2 TO's). UO's gm vs Wash was canceled but the Ducks made the P12 title game when Wash was unable to go (covid) & UO upset USC 31-24 (14 pts off TO's). UO's OFF put up 18 ypg above what their foes all'd & QB Shough hit 63% while RB Dye avg'd 7.0 ypc. UO has a solid pass D (#13) but struggled at times to stop the run (269 yds, 6.1 ypg OSU) and they had 7 sks the L/2 gms

ISU ret'd 13 st's incl QB Purdy and 8 st's on DEF. Despite outgaining LA in the opener ISU lost 31-14 (LA 2 ST td's) then won at TCU. ISU then won vs OU 37-30 (trailing 17-6 2Q). After a win vs TTech, ISU lost at OSU by 3 then won by 30 at Kan. ISU continued their win streak vs Bay & KSt before winning at Tex 23-20 (ISU GW TD with 75 sec left). ISU closed out the ssn with a 42-6 win vs WVU (483-263) before losing to OU in the B12 title game. While QB Purdy came on strong at the end he did throw 3 int's vs OU and ISU best OFF player was RB Hall (1436, 5.9, 19 td) & the OL all'd just 13 sks on 344 pass att. ISU's DEF led by B12 DPOY LB Rose, held foes to 66 ypg under their ssn avg & had 28 sks led by DE McDonald (9 sks).

While we prefer to play on ISU as an underdog, the Ducks won the Pac-12 title despite not winning their division & we think ISU's strong defense & run game lead them to a win here.

4★ INDIANAPOLIS over Jacksonville - After a costly road loss to the Steelers a week ago in a game that they blew a 17 pt 2H lead in, the Colts return home to take on a Jags squad that suffered a 24 pt blowout loss a week ago at home against the Bears (3★ LP Winner on CHI!). In one of the biggest head-scratchers for the entire 2020 ssn, the Jaguars (+8) picked up a shocking 27-20 Wk 1 home upset of the Colts for their only win of the year (lost 14 straight since, outscored by 13 ppg). With JAX well on their way to winning the Trevor Lawrence sweepstakes, we have no problem backing a playoff-needy Colts team that's picked up covers in 6 of their L/8 ssn finales.

FORECAST: INDIANAPOLIS by 21

3★ Atlanta over TAMPA BAY - Revenge time for a Falcons squad that blew a 17-0 HT lead to the Bucs just 2 wks ago at home (TB 416-369 yd edge in 4 pt win). ATL nearly picked up an upset of the Chiefs LW in Arrowhead as a DD dog (missed tying FG w/:09 left) while the Bucs jumped out to a 34-0 HT lead in their playoff-clinching victory over DET (QB Brady 348 yds & 4 TD's in 1H). Although ATL is just 3-8 ATS in NFC South away matchups coming in and TB still has an opportunity to climb higher in the WC rankings, keep in mind that over the past 11 years, when 2 DIV squads play each other twice in a 3-week span, the losing team from the 1st matchup has gone an outstanding 20-5 ATS in the rematch.

FORECAST: Atlanta by 3

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ CINCINNATI (+) over Baltimore - After a 14 pt home win against the Giants to stay alive for a WC spot inside of the AFC, the Ravens head to CIN to take on a Bengals squad that's on an impressive 6-1-1 ATS in recent home matchups including an outright upset of PIT (+14) 2 wks ago on MNF. The Bengals also picked up a 2nd consec outright upset LW in HOU with a ssn-best 37 pts and 540 yds. In the Bengals' Wk 5 trip to BAL, their offense was held to just 3 pts and 205 yds in a 24 pt defeat (3rd consec series win for the Ravens). While the Ravens are 9-3 ATS in recent AG's, it was just 3 yrs ago when CIN (+9) picked up the outright upset of BAL who needed a Wk 17 win to earn the final playoff spot.

FORECAST: Baltimore by 3

OTHER PLAYS

Washington at PHILADELPHIA - SNF - Following a 20 pt road defeat in DAL to find themselves eliminated from NFC East contention, the Eagles now have the chance to play spoiler at home against WAS who dropped a 7 pt contest at home against CAR to keep the Cowboys and Giants within range of stealing away the DIV title. In PHI's Wk 1 trip to the nation's capital, WAS ended a 6-gm series losing skid by overcoming a 17-7 HT deficit in the eventual 10 pt victory. While QB Smith is expected to return here following an injury that's seen him sidelined for each of the past 2 contests, the emergence of rookie QB Hurts under center gives PHI a fighting chance in this one. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Green Bay by 1 over CHICAGO - Following an easy 26 pt home win against the Titans to stay atop the overall NFC standings, the Packers head into Soldier Field to take on a Bears team that's rattled off 3 consec wins including a relatively easy 24 pt victory over a 1-win Jaguars squad (3★ LP Winner on CHI!). In their late Nov meeting in Lambeau, the Packers (-8) came out victorious for the 8th time in 9 tries (led 41-10 after 3Q) thanks in part to QB Rodgers' 4 TD passes. While the Bears still need a win here to clinch one of the final WC spots, a win by the Packers would cement them in to the #1 spot in the NFC.

Dallas by 3 over NY GIANTS - The Cowboys remained alive for the NFC East Title following a 20 pt victory over the Eagles where QB Dalton threw for 377 yds and 3 TD's. The Giants are also alive despite a 3-game losing skid coming in as BAL finished with a 432-269 yd edge in a 14 pt win. The Cowboys' 37-34 home victory (-8) over the Giants back in Wk 5 was their 7th consec series win (6-1 ATS, 12 pt avg MOV). With the Giants sliding and the Cowboys putting together their best offensive performance a week ago since losing Dak Prescott, we'll call for the visitor to pick up a 3 pt victory and potentially claim the DIV crown depending on the WAS/PHI results.

CLEVELAND by 10 over Pittsburgh - The Steelers have dominated this series dating back to '04 with a 28-4-1 SU (19-14 ATS) that includes a 38-7 (-3) victory earlier TY in Heinz Field where CLE was held to ssn-lows in FD's (12) and yds (220). They do however head into this matchup with not much on the line as LW's comeback win over IND (overcame 17 pt 2H deficit) saw them claim the AFC North Title. The Browns meanwhile saw Covid restrictions hamper their offensive gameplan in LW's loss to the Jets as their entire WR unit was forced out due to contact tracing (7 pt loss as 6' pt chalk). With CLE now needing a victory here to claim one of the WC spots, we'll give them a DD advantage in this one with PIT likely resting some of their key contributors on both sides of the ball.

Tennessee by 10 over HOUSTON - The Texans are back at home for a 2nd consec week following a surprising loss to the Bengals where they allowed 37 pts and 540 yds. The Titans meanwhile dropped a 26 pt contest LW in snowy Lambeau against the Packers who finished with 27-15 FD and 448-260 yd edges. In HOU's Wk 6 trip to Nashville earlier TY, the Titans (-3') picked up the 42-36 OT victory with a franchise-best 601 yds (RB Henry 265 tl yds, 2 TD's). With playoff need clearly on the mind of the Titans (4-1 ATS run in DIV AG's) in this one along with the Texans failing to cover 7 of their L/9 home matchups, we have no issue backing the visitor in this one (HOU ranked #31 in NFL all'g 152 ypg rush).

New Orleans by 4 over CAROLINA - Following a 19 pt home victory on Christmas against the Vikings where they clinched the NFC South for a 4th consec year (RB Kamara 155 rush yds & 6 TD's!), the Saints head to Charlotte to take on a CAR squad that took advantage of 4 WAS TO's in a 20-13 victory (WAS 386-280 yd edge). In their earlier 2020 meeting, the Saints knocked off the Panthers for the 7th time in 8 tries with 26-18 FD & 415-283 yd edges (CAR just missed the tying 65-yd FG w/:55 left). While NO is on a solid 17-6 ATS run away from the Superdome, they could be pulling starters in the 2H depending on what's going on with both GB and SEA.

NEW ENGLAND by 7 over NY Jets - After a MNF meeting against the AFC East-winning Bills, the Patriots (missing playoffs for 1st time since '08) finish up their 2020 campaign at home against a Jets squad that surprisingly picked up a 2nd consec upset win LW at home against a shorthanded Browns squad. In their 1st meeting back in Wk 9 on MNF, the Patriots (-9') overcame a 20-10 HT deficit connecting on a 51-yd FG as time expired for the 30-27 win (NE's 9th consec series win, 19 pt avg MOV). With the Patriots covering 4 of their L/5 contests in Foxboro as of presstime, we'll go ahead and call for them to end a rough 2020 campaign on a positive note.

Minnesota by 10 over DETROIT - Following a substantial beatdown inside of the Superdome on Christmas where the Saints had 36-25 FD and 583-364 yd edges, the Vikings head into Ford Field having covered 6 of their L/8 ssn finales. DET meanwhile clinched last place in the NFC North for the 3rd consec year following a 40 pt home defeat against the Bucs where QB Stafford was lost early to an ankle inj (CS here). The Lions have dropped 6 consec matchups

against the Vikings (0-5-1 ATS, 13 pt avg loss) including a early Nov trip to US Bank Stadium where MIN took advantage of 3 DET int's in a 34-20 win. With DET also going just 8-19 ATS as a HD coming in, we have no issue giving the visitor a solid lean in this one.

Miami by 7 over BUFFALO - The Dolphins moved one step closer to earning a WC berth following their miracle 26-25 victory over LV with Fitzpatrick taking over for the ineffective Tagovailoa late. BUF meanwhile might not have much to play for here following a MNF matchup against NE (BUF has already clinched their DIV). In their Wk 2 matchup in South Beach, the Bills (-5') picked up a 31-28 victory for their 6th win in 7 tries against the Dolphins (QB Allen 417 pass yds & 4 TD's). While the Bills are on a 6-0 ATS run as of presstime, potential rest of starters for BUF and playoff need for MIA (6-1 ATS vs AFC East foes) have us leaning with the visitor in this one.

La Chargers by 7 over KANSAS CITY - Following a narrow 3 pt home victory over the Falcons where they clinched the #1 spot (and 1st Rnd bye) in the AFC (ATL missed game-tying 39-yd FG w/:09 left), the Chiefs are back inside of Arrowhead for a meaningless contest against a Chargers team that also picked up a 3 pt victory with a GW 37-yd FG w/:41 left (DEN 396-316 yd edge, -2 TO's). While the Chiefs have won 11 of the last 12 against the Chargers coming in (8-4 ATS), they did need a late comeback attempt and OT to knock off LA back in Wk 2 (Chargers 28-23 FD & 479-414 yd edges). Despite just a 2-8-1 ATS mark inside of their DIV, we'll go ahead and back the visiting Chargers here as they more than likely match up against bkp QB Henne (last start came in '14) and a handful of other KC reserves (Chiefs are on a 0-6-1 ATS run).

Seattle by 1 over SAN FRANCISCO Game played in Arizona due to Covid restrictions in Santa Clara. The 49ers picked up a surprising victory over the Cardinals LW with 3rd string QB Beathard (13-22-182-3-0) getting the start. The Seahawks meanwhile clinched the NFC West following an 11 pt home victory over the Rams (LA 334-292 yd edge). The 49ers have clearly struggled in recent matchups with the Seahawks as SEA is on an 11-2 SU (9-4 ATS) run including a 37-27 (-3) home victory earlier TY. Despite those issues, we're leaning with them here as the Seahawks could be pulling starters in the 2H depending on what's going on with the Packers.

Las Vegas by 3 over DENVER - Following a 3 pt loss in LA against the Chargers where they allowed a GW 37-yd FG w/:41 left (DEN 23-16 FD & 396-316 yd edges), the Broncos return to "Mile High" having gone just 3-9-1 ATS in recent meetings against DIV foes. The Raiders meanwhile were finally eliminated from the postssn contention after blowing a final second lead last Saturday against MIA. In the Broncos' Wk 10 trip to Vegas, the Raiders (-3') picked up the easy 37-12 victory (DEN QB Lock 4 int's). With DEN failing to cover 4 of their L/5 ssn finales and the Raiders going 6-3 ATS in recent AG's, the visitor gets the FG edge in this one.

Arizona at LA RAMS - After a surprising home loss to the 49ers that also saw them take a substantial hit as far as the playoffs are concerned (need to win and hope that CHI loses to get the final WC spot), the Cardinals head to LA to take on a Rams squad that also needs to pick up a victory in Wk 17 to ensure a WC spot in the NFC after falling 20-9 LW in SEA (334-292 yd edge). The Rams are on a perfect 7-0 SU/ATS run against the Cardinals (21 pt avg MOV) including a early Dec 38-28 victory in the desert. They could however be without the services of QB Goff here (broke thumb vs SEA). We'll pass on a projection for this matchup until we get further information on who is lining up under center for LA.
