4★ Louisiana Tech (+) over Baylor - Baylor is 5-1 all-time vs Louisiana Tech but they haven't met since 1996. Baylor returns 9 starters including QB Brewer (65%, 21-7) but only 2 starters are back on defense and they lost 7 of their top 8 tk'rs. The Bears new head coach Dave Aranda didn't get a single practice with his team in spring. LT has just 8 starters back but HC Holtz does his best work with young teams. The Bulldogs also added FCS transfer QB Luke Anthony who played well against two FBS foes during his time at Abilene Christian (258 ypg, 67%, 4-2). RB Justin Henderson had 1,062 (5.6) last year and the OLine returns 2 starters but also adds an LSU transfer. Holtz is on runs of 14-6 as an away dog and 19-11 vs non-conference foes while Baylor is just 3-8 as both home chalk and against non-conference foes. Holtz has struggled vs Power-5 foes (0-11 on the road) but they did cover vs #6 LSU in '18 and nearly beat Arkansas in '16's opener as 24' point dogs.

FORECAST: BAYLOR by 7

3★ SOUTH ALABAMA (+) over Tulane - Only other meeting was back in '13 when SAAla (+6) came away with the win 41-39 (465-372) at Tulane. This is the first game for South Alabama in their new stadium, but the capacity will be limited to 25%. We gave out a Free Marquee winner to Newsletter subscribers on Thursday when South Alabama got their first road win under HC Campbell last week, pulling the outright upset as nearly 2 td underdogs, 32-21 vs SMiss. QB Trotter looked good (299 yds, 2-2) & two WR's went for over 100 yds, however Trotter left the game late 4Q limping and his injury status is unknown as of presstime. Tulane ran for 243 ypg LY but lose their QB (who was also the #1 rusher LY) and their top 2 RB's and WR's, but do return 7 DEF st'rs. South Alabama is on a 9-4 ATS run as a dog, and were 4-1 ATS LY as a home dog. Tulane is 2-4 ATS in road openers, but run a version of the option with former Georgia Southern HC Fritz. Last year South Alabama faced the option vs Georgia Southern and while they only lost 20-17 in OT, they gave up 310 rush yds. The Jaguars will be fired up to play in their new stadium, and after their impressive win last week we think they could pull another outright upset.

FORECAST: Tulane by 4

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ ARMY over Ulm - First meeting. Only cadets will be in attendance. Army returns 12 st'rs (5 OFF/7 DEF) and while they lose QB Hopkins (7 st, 710 rush, 577 pass) Christian Anderson looked solid running the option last week in a 42-0 win (368-184) vs Middle Tenn. ULM brings back 13 st'rs (5 OFF/8 DEF) but two of them opted out and will have to replace starting QB Caleb Evans who left as the #2 all-time passer & #6 all-time rusher. ULM does get back RB Josh Johnson (1298, 6.5, 11 td) and TE Josh Pederson (43 rec, 567 yds, 9 td), but lose 4 of their top 7 tk'rs. ULM has faced GStHrn the L2Y, so they are familiar with the option, but their run DEF last ssn was #128 in the FBS, all g 253 ypg (5.7 ypc) and their 5th-year DC stepped down just last week. Army looks to have the stronger DEF (held MT to 184 yds, 13 FD last week) and with ULM's struggles against the run we think Army takes this game by over 3 td's. We won a 2★ on these pages then upgraded to a 2★ LPS on Army last week and we will go back to the well again.

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 10TH

Uab at MIAMI, FL - First meeting. The Blazers have lost vs 3 Power 5 foes by 24 ppg the last 3 years but were only outgained by 46 ypg in the last 2 vs Tenn & A&M. UAB is one of the most experienced teams in the country with 15 starters back from a 9 win squad. Their 10 point win over Central Ark last week was deceiving as the Blazers allowed 2 short td drives off TO's in the 1H, a fumble return td and 2 late td's in garbage time that accounted for 148 of Central Ark's 293 yds. UM is one of the most improved teams in the country thanks to the additions of QB D'Erig King (Houston) and Quincy Roche (Temple). The 'Canes have 12 starters back but did lose AA DE Rousseau (opted out). The 'Canes struggled when they were chalk of 7 points or more last year, going 0-6 ATS with 5 outright losses! UAB didn't fare much better as away dogs, going 0-3 with losses of 23, 35 & 43 points.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 12TH

NORTH CAROLINA by 15 over Syracuse - NC has lost the last 2 meetings vs Cuse but this is only the 2nd ACC meeting and it's the first in Chapel Hill. The Orange have just 11 starters back but 7 are on offense including QB Tommy DeVito (63%, 19-5). Mack Brown has the Tar Heels back in ACC contention with 17 returning starters including QB Sam Howell (61%, 38-7) along with two 1,000 yd WR's and two RB's that topped 900 yards. NC has a huge edge on defense with 10 starters back. The Tar Heels finished '19 on a 3 game win streak by 41 ppg. Syracuse did pull 2 upsets in their last 3 to end '19. HC Babers is 4-12 SU but 9-7 ATS in ACC road games and with no fans in attendance we will call for the Orange to score enough to stay within the opening line.

APPALACHIAN ST by 21 over Charlotte - 3rd mtg. App St (-14) dominated in '17 with a 45-9 win at UC, but LY App St (-22') jumped out to a 42-20 lead, but needed a late KR TD and an INT to win 56-41. App enters with their 3rd HC in 3 years, but the OFF returns QB Zac Thomas (2718, 62.7%, 28-6, 440 rush yds) and 4 st'rs from the OLine, but WR Corey Sutton (7 st, 601, 14.7 LY) opted out. UC also brings back a starting QB in Chris Reynolds (2564, 62.2%, 22-11, 791 rush) and they add RB Tre Harbison (2055 rush yds L2Y at NIU). Both DEF's lose their top 3 tk'rs, but return talent as App St (5 DEF st'rs back) all'd 336 ypg & 20 ppg LY and UC (6 DEF st'rs back) all'd 381 ypg & 32.4 ppg LY. App St is 7-1 ATS the L2Y in non-conf gms and UC had losses of 42, 18, 25 & 22 last year so the Mountaineers could easily win this game by 3 td's.

FLORIDA ST by 17 over Georgia Tech - First meeting since '15 when GT upset #9 FSU 22-16 at home. The dog is 5-1 ATS in this series. FSU has lost their last 3 season openers including twice as chalk. The 'Noles return 17 starters including 10 on defense led by 1st Tm ACC NT Marvin Wilson. QB Blackman was named the starter (63%, 17-11). GT is the most experienced team in the country with 19 starters back. They were -151 ypg in ACC play last year but are in their 2nd year under Collins (going away from triple option) and should show significant improvement, especially at Oline where they have 3 SEC transfers. HC Norvell only got 3 practices with his new team in spring but this is still an experienced team and the 'Noles will have some home field edge with up to nearly 20,000 fans in the stands. FSU was -30 ypg and 6-2 ATS vs ACC foes last year while GT was -151 ypg and 2-6 ATS. With both teams improved we will lean with the more talented 'Noles.

LOUISVILLE by 8 over WKU - Last year was at a Neutral site and UL led 31-7 at half, going on to win by 17. The Cardinals have 16 starters back and are in their 2nd year under HC Satterfield. The offense has a ton of firepower, returning QB Cunningham (63%, 22-5), RB Hawkins (1,525, 5.8) and WR Atwell (1,276, 18.2). WKU has 16 starters back including 9 on defense (top 6 tk'rs back) in their 2nd year under HC Helton. They also add Maryland transfer QB Tyrell Pigrome (7 career starts). UL will have up to 18,000 fans in attendance so there is some home field edge but the 'Toppers were best in this role last year, going 4-0 as road dogs including a route over Power-5 foe Arkansas. WKU was actually 6-1 as underdogs last year with 5 outright upsets but the only non-cover was against UL. This should be a competitive game and while we think UL wins by more than a touchdown, it won't be quite enough to cover the early Vegas line.

Clemson by 28 over WAKE FOREST - Clemson is on a series-record 11 game win streak vs WF including a 52-3 thrashing last year. The Tigers have won their last 5 ACC openers by 23 ppg, though last year they needed a late 51 yd fg to cover over Georgia Tech. WF lost QB Newman (transfer) and WR Surratt (opted out) in the offseason. They still have experience at QB with Sam Hartman who

actually beat out Newman 2 years ago before getting injured and has 10 career starts under his belt. Clemson only has 11 returning starters but they are clearly Nat'l Title contenders with QB Lawrence and RB Etienne returning. The Tigers also return their entire Dline which should be a major issue against a WF offense that has just 2 starters back. WF has an improved D with 8 starters back led by 1st Tm ACC DE Boogie Basham. Clemson did cover 8 straight prior to LY's Nat'l Title but they've been slow starters the last 2 years so we will give a slight lean to the underdog.

NOTRE DAME by 27 over Duke - ND has won 2 of the last 3 meetings but Duke did pull an upset LTH in '16, winning 38-35 as nearly 3 td underdogs. ND hammered Duke on the road last year, 38-7 while holding the Blue Devils to a season low 197 yards. The Irish finished '19 on a 6 game win streak (+179 ypg) including covering their L5. Duke lost 5 straight (-175 ypg) before upsetting a depleted Miami squad in the season finale. The Irish have 12 starters back but they do lose their leading rusher and top 3 receivers. Duke has 14 starters back and adds Clemson transfer QB Chase Brice. ND was 5-2 as a home favorite last year and will have up to 15,525 fans in attendance. Duke is 28-16 as underdogs the last 7 years but Cutcliffe is just 2-7 as dogs of 20+ points.

IOWA ST by 7 over Louisiana - First meeting. No fans will be in attendance. This is LA's first meeting vs a Big 12 school s/'13 when they travelled to K-State (+11) and lost 48-27. ISU faced an SBC team LY in ULM & won 72-20. ISU brings back just 5 st'rs on OFF but two of those returnees are QB Purdy (3982, 65.7%, 27-9) and RB Hall (897, 4.8, 9 td) and 2 of the top 4 WR's return too. LA returns 7 st'rs on OFF incl QB Lewis (3050, 64.3%, 26-4) and RB's Mitchell (1147, 5.8, 16 td) and Ragans (820, 7.1, 11 td) plus a strong OL. ISU's DEF all'd 369 ypg & 25.9 ppg LY and return 8 st'rs from that DEF, while LA brings back 7 st'rs from a talented unit LY that all'd 372 ypg & 19.7 ppg. ISU is just 2-7 the L2Y as DD home chalk while LA is 5-1-1 ATS under HC Napier as an AD. LA also comes in as the more exp'd team (#13 vs. #81). Last season LA (+19) faced Miss St and hung with them, losing by just 10 pts. While we think ISU gets the win, we expect LA to hang around.

TEXAS by 45 over Utep - Texas is 5-0 vs UTEP, winning by an average score of 39-7. The last meeting was in '16, the 'Horns won 41-7. UTEP is one of the youngest teams in the country with just 10 returning starters but they have a game under their belt after beating Stephen F Austin 24-14. UTEP did trail 14-3 2Q but held SFA to 230 tl yards. Texas has 16 starters back including QB Ehlinger (65%, 32-10) and 9 starters return on defense. The Horns hammered two CUSA foes last year, beating Rice 48-13 and LA Tech 45-14 in their opener (-20). UTEP lost to those two squads by 16 & 21 points. Herman has traditionally been better in the underdog role but Texas is 8-4 ATS vs non conference foes including 3-2 when favored by 20+. HC Dimel is 1-7 ATS vs non-conference foes and they have a more winnable game on deck vs Abilene Christian.

TEXAS ST by 7 over Utsa - Utsa has won all 3 mtgs. In their last mtg '18 UTSA (-7) hosted TXSt & recorded a late safety to win 25-21 (272-248, TXSt 3 TO's). TXSt played last week vs SMU and lost a close gm 31-24, giving us a marquee winner on the UNDER 69'. This is UTSA's first game. The RoadRunners returns 8 OFF st'rs, but their starting QB will not be made public until kickoff. Utsa also brings back RB McCormick (983, 5.6, 8 td). TXSt's OFF looked good vs SMU (416 yds, 22 FD) and will have a chance to do more here against a UTSA DEF that all'd 429 ypg & 33.9 ppg LY and returns just 5 st'rs. TXSt returns only 4 st'rs on DEF and did give up 544 yds & 31 pts last week to SMU. The Bobcats impressed us last week against an experienced SMU team, and with having a game under their belt we think the Bobcats win by a td.

OKLAHOMA ST by 15 over Tulsa - 76th meeting. OKSt has won the L7 mtgs SU and the L4 mtgs ATS. These teams met last year and Tulsa (+14) actually led 21-20 at HT (258-243) but were shut out in the 2H and OSU won 40-21 (506-396). OKSt returns 17 st'rs (7 OFF/10 DEF) including star RB Hubbard (2094, 6.4, 21 td) and star WR Wallace (903, 17.0, 8 td) and the Cowboys return 12 of the top 13 tk'rs. Tulsa returns 9 starters to an offense that put up 420 ypg LY as QB Smith (3279, 57.3, 19-9) is back along with the top 2 RB's, top 2 WR's and 4 starting OL. The Tulsa defense did hold foes to 395 ypg last year but brings back just 4 starters & lose 5 of the top 8 tacklers. OSU was 5-1 ATS LY as double-digit home chalk, but Tulsa was 3-1 ATS LY as a double-digit road dog. OSU has the stronger team, but Tulsa hung around LY and with no fans in the stands, there is a minimal home edge and that will help Tulsa keep this game within the line.

KANSAS ST by 13 over Ark St - 3rd meeting, but first since 1980 when KSt won at home 31-7. KSt is only allowing 25% capacity for this game. Ark St comes in with a game under their belt, losing at Memphis 37-24 (outgained 502-424). Both QB's Hatcher and Bonner saw time, and starting RB Murray DNP last week. KSt returns just 9 st'rs but QB Thompson (2315, 59.6, 12-5, 405 rush, 11 td) is one of them. KSt's DEF was solid LY (all'd 368 ypg & 21.4 ppg) and they bring back 6 st'rs. Ark St is just 5-12 ATS the L5Y vs non-conf foes while KSt is on an 8-2 ATS run in their first home game vs an FBS foe. Ark St does also have the edge of getting in 11 spring practices, while KSt got in ZERO and Ark St comes in as the more exp'd team overall (#25 vs #113). Ark St has the edge on OFF, but KSt has a significant edge on DEF and that will be the difference in the game as we see KSt winning by nearly 2 td's.



UNDERDOG PLAY OF THE WEEK

Over 38 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 38 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years including 2 more outright upsets last year. Here is This week's Underdog Play:

Coastal Carolina +4 over KANSAS

Coastal Carolina by 3 over KANSAS - These teams were set to meet at CCar, but the game is now in Lawrence in front of no fans. LY CCar (+7) came into Lawrence and outgained KU 291-280 (CCar 20-17 FD edge) and forced 2 INT's in a 12-7 win. KU is breaking in a new starting QB, but their top 2 WR's return & KU will rely heavily on star RB Pooka Williams (1061, 5.2 LY), but they return just 2 OL st'rs. CCar returns 14 st'rs (8 OFF, 6 DEF) and RB CJ Marable (1085, 5.3, 11 td) will again be the focal point of an OFF that also has 4 starting OL back. CCar all'd 160 rush ypg LY & return a strong DLine (3 ret st'rs) along with their top LB. The KU DEF all'd 172 rush yds LY to CCar & overall LY all'd 226 rush ypg (4.9 ypc). CCar also got in all 15 spring practices while KU got in ZERO. CCar is 9-4-1 ATS the L3Y as an AD, while KU is just 3-6 as a HF the L5Y, and we expect CCar to keep this game close & possibly pull another upset in Lawrence.

4★ Pittsburgh over NY GIANTS - MNF - The Steelers return to action with a familiar face under center in Roethlisberger who missed nearly the entire '19 season (PIT fell from #4 to #30 in total offense!). The Giants meanwhile begin their 1st season without Eli Manning as opening day starter with 2nd year QB Jones ready to lead the franchise. In their most recent matchup back in '16, the Steelers (-7) jumped out to a 14-0 lead en route to a 10 pt win (389-234 yd edge). While the Giants have gone 13-6 ATS against AFC foes, they have failed to cover 10 of their last 11 as a HD. With no fans on hand inside of MetLife Stadium and the Giants failing to cover 8 consecutive home openers, we're backing the visitor here as the Steelers have covered 6 of their last 8 against the NFC.

FORECAST: Pittsburgh by 13

3★ CAROLINA over Las Vegas - The Raiders head to hot and humid Charlotte for the ssn opener before returning to Las Vegas on MNF against the Saints for their very first home contest in their brand new venue. The Panthers on the other hand will have a new face under center with journeyman Bridgewater taking over for the now departed Newton. In their most recent matchup back in '16, the Raiders (-3) jumped out to a 24-7 HT lead before CAR actually took the lead early in the 4Q. The Raiders would score the final 11 pts including a GW 23 yd FG w/1:45 left. While the Raiders are on a 6-1 ATS run in road openers, they have gone just 5-13-2 ATS against the NFC. The Panthers on the other hand have covered 10 of their past 14 against the AFC and should be able to get the mild home upset here.

FORECAST: CAROLINA by 6

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Green Bay over MINNESOTA - Following an outstanding 1st year for HC LaFleur where they went 13-3 (victory away from SB), the Packers head into action having covered 4 of their past 5 ssn opening matchups. The Vikings meanwhile also tasted a playoff victory a year ago before falling to SF in the DIV round. Their defense will look much different in '20 however as they made wholesale changes with both their DL and DB positions. The Packers have covered 4 consec meetings in this series including a 23-10 upset road victory (+5) LY in Wk 16 where they held MIN to just 7 FD's and 139 yds. While the Vikings are 22-8-1 ATS as a HF, we expect their newly formed defense to be tested early and often in this one.

FORECAST: Green Bay by 4

OTHER PLAYS

Houston at KANSAS CITY - Thursday - The Chiefs head into action having covered 9 straight following their SB win over the 49ers. One of those covers came in their postssn matchup against the Texans (+10) a year ago in Arrowhead. HOU jumped out to a 24-0 lead early in the 2Q before the Chiefs would score 51 of the final 58 pts in a 20 pt win (QB Mahomes 321 yds, 5 TD). While the Texans do get a healthy Watt back on the DL and have covered 9 of their past 12 as a NDIV AD, keep in mind that the defending champs have cashed 4 of their L/5 ssn openers heading in.

We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

NEW ENGLAND by 3 over Miami - The Patriots have captured the AFC East in 16 of the past 17 years with the Dolphins ('08) the only other squad to earn a DIV title in that span. If they're going to do it again TY, it will be without future HOF QB Brady who moves down to Tampa. In their final meeting of a year ago the Patriots (-16) suffered a surprising 27-24 defeat in Foxboro (MIA GW TD pass w/2:44 left) that saw them slip into the #3 spot in the AFC (1st time s/'09 not earning a bye). The Dolphins were a perfect 3-0 ATS as a DIV AD LY and will get the advantage of playing inside an empty Gillette Stadium. While the Patriots have covered 8 of their past 12 as a DIV HF, the Dolphins' 6-1 ATS mark in ssn openers has us taking the points.

BALTIMORE by 13 over Cleveland - Following an early 2-2 start LY that included a surprising 15 pt home loss to the Browns as a TD favorite (CLE's 40 pts & 530 yds were the most BAL all'd in '19), the Ravens would go on to rattle off 12 consec victories to end the regular ssn (16 pt win at CLE as 10 pt chalk in Wk 16). BAL does however return to action with a bad taste in their mouth as they had no answer for the TEN defense in LY's DIV playoff round. The Browns were one of the bigger disappointments in '19 which prompted yet another coaching change (8th different HC s/'10). The Ravens have won and covered 4 consec ssn openers with an outstanding 35-5 avg MOV. The Browns meanwhile haven't won a Wk 1 contest since way back in 2004 (4-10-1 ATS)!

BUFFALO by 10 over NY Jets - Last year the Bills and Jets had a pair of low-scoring affairs with the Bills escaping with a 17-16 road win in the opener as a 3 pt dog and the Jets getting the upset in the ssn finale (13-6, +1). In fact, these 2 have split their ssn series in each of the past 3 years. The Bills added some offensive talent this offssn with WR Diggins giving QB Allen another target to work with. The Jets on the other hand lose some key players on defense with S Adams being traded to SEA and LB Mosley choosing to opt out. With BUF 11-4 ATS in openers and the Jets having failed to cover 10 of their L/13 overall inside of the AFC East, the Bills get the lean in this one.

Seattle by 3 over ATLANTA - The Seahawks head to the Southeast having failed to cover 5 consec ssn openers while ATL comes into Wk 1 action having struggled themselves with an 0-4 ATS mark (1-3 SU). In their home meeting with SEA a year ago the Falcons (+8) would fall 27-20 (trailed 24-0 at HT) despite a 512-322 yd edge. The defensive side of the ball might be an afterthought in this one as the Seahawks and Falcons both finished in the Top 10 on offense a year ago with their respective stop units finishing in the lower 3rd of the NFL. While ATL is expected to have a limited attendance inside of their home venue, they have gone just 6-15 ATS in NDIV contests heading in.

Philadelphia by 10 over WASHINGTON - Following a rough offseason in D.C. where the former Redskins had plenty of off-field issues to go along with a change in their coaching staff, they are at FedExField for Wk 1 where they have failed to cover 7 of their past 8 home openers. The Eagles have won 6 consec matchups (5-1 ATS, 13 pt avg MOV) in this series including a misleading victory late LY in WAS where they got a GW 4 yd TD pass w/2:26 left followed by a 47 yd FR TD on the final play to win by 10 (-6). With PHI posting an outstanding 6-1 ATS mark as a DIV AF and WAS having failed to cover 15 of their past 19 overall against the NFC East, the smart money should be on the visitor in this one.

Chicago by 2 over DETROIT - The Bears have earned the series sweep in each of the past 2 years (4-0 ATS) including a 24-20 win here LY on Thanksgiving (QB Trubisky 338 yds & 3 TD). The Lions meanwhile have been home chalk on just 3 occasions the L2Y losing all 3 ATS along with 2 outright upsets. Although the Bears are on a rough 3-9 overall ATS run, it's worth mentioning that they're just a year removed from being in the playoffs and have gone 10-3 ATS in DIV matchups. With DET on a 1-7-1 ATS run themselves, a narrow road victory for CHI should be expected.

Indianapolis by 6 over JACKSONVILLE - The Colts head into the ssn opener with some confidence inside of their DIV where they've covered 6 of the past 8 matchups. The Jaguars meanwhile have been on the opposite end having failed to cash 6 of their past 8 AFC South matchups. However, following LY's ssn-ending 38-20 victory (+6) over the Colts where QB Minshew threw for 295 yds & 3 TD, the Jaguars have now knocked off IND on 4 consec occasions inside of their home venue with a surprising 20 pt avg MOV. Despite having gone just 1-7 ATS in home openers, we're leaning with the dog here as the heat and humidity of JAX could affect the Colts (play in a dome) as the game wears on.

La Chargers by 1 over CINCINNATI - Following 14 seasons as QB of the Chargers, Philip Rivers moves on to IND with journeyman Tyrod Taylor expected to take the bulk of the snaps in this one. The Bengals also part ways with their long-time starting QB (Andy Dalton L9Y) with #1 overall pick Joe Burrow taking over the duties. These 2 last met back in '18 where the Chargers (-14) earned a 26-21 victory (ended CIN's 4-gm series win streak). While the Bengals are on a 3-7 ATS run against NDIV foes, we'll go ahead and take the points in this one as the Chargers have now failed to cover 12 of the L/16 heading in and begin with a long trip East.

SAN FRANCISCO by 6 over Arizona - The 49ers return to action after a SB loss to the Chiefs where they led 20-10 heading into the final quarter (outscored 21-0 in 4Q). The Cardinals meanwhile showed some progress LY under rookie HC Kingsbury and QB Murray and have now covered 9 of their past 12 road openers. Following a perfect 4-0 SU mark (3-1 ATS) the 2 years prior against SF, the Cardinals fell to the 49ers in both matchups a season ago including a 28-25 defeat (+10) on Halloween night in the desert (ARZ 88 yd TD pass w/4:53 left for backdoor cover). With an 11-5-1 ATS mark as a DIV AD for the Cardinals and the 49ers having gone 5-13-1 ATS as a HF, we'll give a slight lean with the dog.

NEW ORLEANS by 4 over Tampa Bay - This is arguably the most anticipated Wk 1 matchup with future HOF QB Brady taking his new Bucs squad into the Superdome to take on the Saints. In prior Brady vs Brees (w/NO) matchups, the former owns a 2-1 advantage including a 36-20 "Big Easy" win in '17 where the 2 combined for 803 yds & 5 TD! In the 2 matchups between the Bucs and Saints a season ago, NO would pick up a pair of SU/ATS victories. While the Saints have routinely struggled early in the year including 5 consecutive failed covers in home openers, they are on an 11-3 ATS run overall. Tough to lean in the direction of either side here, especially with no preseason matchups to see how the new Bucs offense will look.

LA RAMS at Dallas - SNF - Following a disappointing season for both squads a year ago, the Cowboys head into brand new SoFi Stadium to take on a Rams squad that has covered each of their last 5 home openers. In their trip to DAL a year ago, the Rams suffered a thorough beatdown by the Cowboys who finished with a 475-289 yd advantage (DAL RB's Elliott & Pollard 100+ rush yds). While the Cowboys have covered 7 of their previous 9 road openers, the Rams did cover 4 of their final 5 a year ago and are just a season removed from representing the NFC in the Super Bowl. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Tennessee at DENVER - MNF - The Broncos open up their ssn on MNF for the 3rd time in 4 ssn as they take on a Titans squad that shocked both the Patriots and Ravens LY in the playoffs before getting knocked out by KC in the AFC Title gm. In their "Mile High" meeting a year ago in mid Oct, the Broncos held the Titans to just 12 FD's and 204 yds in the 16-0 victory (DEN 7 sks & 3 int). Although TEN is 6-1 ATS in road openers, the Broncos have been just as impressive against NDIV foes going 6-3-1 ATS.
