KEY SELECTIONS

4★ TCU over California - Only prior meeting for these teams was back in the 2018 Cheez-It Bowl where TCU would go on to beat Cal 10-7 in overtime. TCU is off an easy 45-3 win against FCS Duquesne where they actually shortened the 3Q and 4Q to 12 minutes each. Cal hosted Nevada this past week & jumped out to a 14-0 lead after their F2 drives, but were held to just 195 yds & 3 pts the rest of the way as Nevada pulled the outright upset (**3★** Late Phone Winner on Nev). TCU returns 18 st's led by QB Max Duggan on offense and DE Ochaun Mathis on defense. Cal also has an exp'd team back with 17 returning st's including QB Garbers and 9 st's on defense. TCU did have more success LY running the ball (215, 5.2) as they threw for just 196 ypg. Cal did allow 312 pass yds last wk, but held Nevada to just 61 rush yds. TCU typically has a strong D, and Cal struggled to move the ball for much of last wk. We have a strong lean on TCU as they are 6-2-1 ATS s/18 against non-conf foes and we think the Horned Frogs will roll by more than 2 td's. **FORECAST: TCU by 17**

3★ Wyoming over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - Only prior mtg was in '16 when WY hosted NIU. In that game neither team led by more than 10 and Wyoming (+9) would come away with a 40-34 win in 3 OT. Wyoming is off a game against FCS Montana St while NIU is off a trip to Georgia Tech. NIU added Mich St transfer QB Rocky Lombardi and he led an upset win over GTech last week. The Huskies led 14-0 2Q. They didn't score again until :38 left and added a GW 2 pt conv. Wyoming is one of the most experienced teams in the country (#3) as they return 10 st's on defense and all 11 starters on defense. NIU is #104 in experience despite returning 19 st's as their biggest loss was QB Bowers. LY Wyoming ran for 220 ypg (4.8) and face an NIU D that all'd 174 rush ypg LY and 273 last week. Wyoming does struggle to pass the ball (153 ypg LY) but they face a young NIU secondary that finished #112 LY. Wyoming went 1-3 ATS LY as road chalk, but we think the significant experience edge & their strong rush attack & defense will propel them to a win. NIU is just 1-5-1 ATS as a home underdog since 2016 and are off an extremely emotional win. **FORECAST: WYOMING by 17**

3★ KENTUCKY over Missouri - KY is out for revenge after last year's 20-10 (-3) loss at MO where the 'Cats were out'd 421-145. Prior to last year KY had won 5 straight mtgs (4-1 ATS). The 'Cats are in much better shape on offense since that game when they started Joey Gatewood who has since transferred and they added Penn St transfer Will Lewis. New OC Liam Coen came here to revitalize the 'Cats passing game and it's had an immediate affect as Lewis' 367 pass yards (69%, 4-1) last week vs ULM was KY's first 300 yard passing game since 2016. MO held off CMich 34-24 (-14). The Tigers trailed the Chips' 14-7 2Q and was actually outgained 475-468. Mizzou's young secondary allowed 301 pass yds. While it's hard to gauge how good KY's offense is after playing a weak opponent, they weren't throwing on anyone the last couple years, regardless of how bad their opponent was and they've still got a solid run game with a stout defense. With a more explosive offense, and a decent edge on D, we think KY wins by DD's. **FORECAST: KENTUCKY by 14**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ NEBRASKA over Buffalo - 1st ever meeting. Nebraska have the Sooners on deck, and are just 3-8 as HF, but Buffalo is 4-8 as AD and are ranked 114th in experience. The Cornhuskers are looking to continue to build momentum after falling behind 30-9 in wk 1A @ Illinois before being upset outright 30-22. The Bulls present a stiffer test than FCS opponent Fordham did LW, as Buffalo dismantled FCS Wagner last Thursday 69-7 with a 569-97 yd edge. Embattled HC Scott Frost desperately needs to find his team's footing before their daunting matchup at Oklahoma. Nebraska is leaning on do-everying DB Cam Taylor-Britt to start to make an impact after his disastrous PR miscue that resulted in a safety and a would-be crucial INT in week 1A that was called back because of two different flags. Taylor-Britt then muffed a punt in the 3Q that was recovered by Fordham LW. The Cornhuskers avenged their only-ever MAC loss (NIU in '17) by dominating the Huskies 44-8 in '19 (-14), their largest FBS win since '15. We expect Nebraska to continue to build momentum and win by 3 TDs. **FORECAST: NEBRASKA by 21**

2★ South Alabama over BOWLING GREEN - These teams met once prior in the Camellia Bowl in 2014 where BG won 33-28. BG is going through some tough times & in a year where many teams have 17+ st's back, the Falcons return just 11 st's including just 4 offensive st's led by QB McDonald. BG's defense does return 7 st's but 5 of the top 7 tkl'rs from LY are gone. Last wk BG did hang with Tennessee in the 1H (down just 14-6 at HT) but would lose 38-6 (219-475). SAla looked impressive in HC Kane Wommack's debut as they took down SMiss 31-7. SAla held only a slight yds edge (300-258) but did force 4 TO's incl getting a pick-six. Transfer QB Bentley looked good in his debut as he hit 77% for 269 yds and 2 td's. SAla only ran for 31 yds last wk but they do face a BG defense that gave up 331 rush yds (5.2) last week. SAla's D all'd under 275 yds and did record 4 sks vs SMiss and now face a BG OL that is littered with freshmen. SAla has only been favored in 6 gms since 2018 but are now 5-1 ATS in those gms. We like the Jags to get a DD road win here as BG is just 2-13 ATS as a home dog dating back to 2017. **FORECAST: South Alabama by 21**

OTHER GAMES

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 10TH

Kansas at COASTAL CAROLINA - 3rd year in a row they meet & CC has pulled the outright upset the L2Y. LY KU had the yds edge (367-318) but were -3 in TO's and lost by 15. Coastal played last Thursday against FCS The Citadel & won 52-14 (610-237) while KU played FCS SDakota last Friday & squeaked out a 17-14 win. Coastal has a game at Buffalo on deck while KU has their B12 opener vs Baylor up next. Coastal is one of the more experienced teams this ssn (#17) while KU is #97 and have a 1st year HC. LY Coastal QB McCall threw for 133 yds (3 td), ran for 73 yds (2 td) against KU. Coastal likes to run the ball (218 ypg, 5.1 ypc LY) and KU's run defense LY gave up 236 ypg (5.8), but Coastal loses their top RB from LY. Leipold was just 6-10-1 ATS as a road dog at Buffalo but Coastal is just 3-7 ATS since joining the FBS as a home favorite. Call 1-800-654-3448 to get our Thurs Night Marquee for \$12!

Utah at BOISE ST - These tms have met 5 times (2000-2004) with Boise St winning all 5 games. In their last meeting Boise won 47-31 in El Paso. Boise St is off a game last Thurs at UCF where they jumped to a 24-7 lead in the 2Q before UCF came back to take a 28-24 lead and Boise eventually lost 36-31 after QB Bachmeier threw a costly INT late. UTEP has 2 gms under their belt with wins over New Mexico St and FCS Bethune-Cookman. UTEP does have 19 st's back incl all 11 st's on offense. Bachmeier hit 64% last week for 263 yds & 2 td's, but the Broncos struggled to run the ball as they ran for 49 yds granted they were missing top RB Holani. His status here is a ? and WR Shakir was limited last week but led with 91 rec yds. UTEP did close last season out on a 4-1 ATS run in road games as an underdog, while Boise St is 7-2 ATS the L2Y at home on the blue turf. UTEP has a bye on deck while Boise hosts OKSt next week.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 11TH

VIRGINIA by 6 over Illinois - Last met back in 1999. Illinois was off their big upset win over Nebraska but without QB Peters against a solid UTSA squad last week. The Illini (-4) never led the entire game after falling behind 14-0 and were outgained 497-412 in a 5 point loss. UVA only led FCS William & Mary 17-0 at half but ultimately pulled away for a 43-0 win (-31). Illinois has a big experience edge (#15 vs #84) but might again be without QB Peters and backup Art Sitkowski only hit 52% last week. UVA was only -20 ypg last year and they have 14 starters back including QB Armstrong. The Cavaliers have been nearly unbeatable at home the last 4 years, now 18-2 SU and on an 8-1 ATS

run at Scott Stadium (6-1 as HF). The dog has pulled an outright upset in each of the first 2 Illinois games but we don't see that happening here as Illinois is only 11-37 SU on the road since 2011. UVA is off a weak foe and will have plenty of energy in front of a home crowd but we think Illinois will play better once again as an underdog so we are calling for the Illini to stay within a touchdown.

ARMY by 3 over Wku - These two last met in Helton's first year at WKU ('19) when the Toppers held Army 185 yds below their average (208 yds) and won 17-8 (+4). Battle of two teams with completely different styles. WKU broke out their new fast paced spread offense last week against UT Martin in a 59-21 win where HBU transfer QB Bailey Zappe threw for 424 and 7 td's. Army was impressive in their opener, beating Georgia St 43-10 (-2), finishing with a 356-177 yard edge. Only 4 starters return on D for WKU. They all'd 171 (4.2) rush ypg last year but gave up 201 (5.9) vs UTM. Army only allowed 161 pass ypg last year but that number is propped up by having faced 5 triple option teams. Army was +92 ypg at home last year while WKU was -82. WKU likely spent extra time prepping for the option over the summer and Helton's team defended it well in '19. We think Army will have just as tough a time prepping for WKU's pass offense so we call for the Toppers to only lose by a field goal.

OHIO ST by 14 over Oregon - The last time these two teams met were in the first ever College Football Playoff Championship in '14, with the Buckeyes coasting to a 42-20 (+6) win. Oregon DE Kayvon Thibodeaux suffered an ankle sprain in the Ducks' 31-24 win against Fresno St LW (-19). The Bulldogs held a +48 yard edge along with a 15-9 FD edge at HT and led 24-21 midway through the 4Q as Thibodeaux could only watch from the sidelines the entire 2H. Ohio St held a slight yd edge but trailed 14-10 by HT at Minnesota (-14) before coming back to win 45-31. OSU QB CJ Stroud had just 13 completions but for 294 yds and 4 TD's in his debut. Oregon is 3-7 ATS vs non-conf foes under HC Mario Cristobal but the Buckeyes are #129 in experience. Thibodeaux is a true gamechanger and arguably the best player in college football, and his potential absence will have a profound impact on the Ducks. We expect OSU to win by 2 TD's, which is right at the opening Vegas line.

Boston College by 35 over UMass - Boston College is 6-0 SU and has covered all 4 lined meetings, winning the last meeting 55-21 (-17) in '18. This is BC's first road trip to UMass since Doug Flutie was BC's QB. The Eagles are 1-3 ATS as 20+ pt chalk with the cover coming last week against FCS Colgate where they cruised 51-0 (-42), though the score was only 30-0 entering the 4Q and BC's final td came with 5:58 left. UMass was +38 last week at Pitt, facing their former HC Whipple (Pitt's OC) but only trailed 37-7 4Q then allowed 2 late td's including one with just 2:44 that cost UMass backers a cover, and pushed the game over the total. The Minutemen offense struggled last year, putting up just 12 points in 4 games and didn't look any better last week (209 yds). UMass is just 4-10 as a HD and BC will likely have more fans here anyways. BC is 4-1 ATS in road openers but this is also the largest number they've been favored by since 2008. The Eagles early state is light to say the least and they've only got Temple on deck. We have a slight lean on the underdog, but it's concerning that BC was adding touchdowns late last week.

Florida by 20 over USF - Only one prior meeting between these in-state schools with Florida winning 38-14 (-16) in 2010. The Gators have won 4 straight road openers. We picked up a marquee winner going against USF last Thursday when the Bulls were completely outmatched in a 45-0 loss. USF trailed 24-0 and was outgained 297-92 in the 1st half. NCar transfer QB Cade Fortin only threw for 41 yards on 20 attempts and was benched for dual threat true frosh Timmy McClain. This year's Florida offense is a polar opposite from last year with a bigger emphasis on the run under mobile QB's Emory Jones and Anthony Richardson. They rushed for 400 yards and led 35-7 (-23) but allowed the Bulls to score with 1:37 left for a backdoor cover. USF's biggest concern is their Dline which was evident last week when they gave up 293 (7.3) rush yds. The Bulls do have the experience edge (#78 vs #121) and this is Scott's second year at USF. The Gators have the edge in the trenches but USF was much better at home last year (-1 ypg at home, -137 ypg on road) and Florida has their huge SEC opener on deck vs Bama so our lean is with the underdog Bulls.

Pittsburgh by 3 over TENNESSEE - This game has been dubbed 'The Johnny Majors Classic', named after the former head coach who led Pitt to a National Title in 1976 then had 11 winning seasons at Tenn before finishing his career at Pitt. These coaches are familiar with each other after splitting 2 mtgs in '18 & '19. Tenn got off to a quick start in their first game under new HC Heupel, scoring td's on their F2 possessions but only ran 7 plays in the 2Q and led lowly Bowling Green just 14-6 at half. The Vols did win 38-6 (-35) and finished w/a 471-219 yd edge. Pitt was -38 and only led 37-7 4Q vs UMass last week then added 2 garbage time td's. Pitt has the edge in experience, with 4Y starter Kenny Pickett coming back (61%, 2408, 13-9). The Panthers did lose 2 All-American DE's but the backups have experience and Tenn all'd 3 sacks vs BG last week. Pitt is 5-2 as an AF. The Vols get extra time to prep, have SEC talent, 7 starters return on defense, but they also lost more players in the portal than any other team and we aren't ready to buy into Heupel's offense just yet so we give Pitt a 3 point edge.

South Carolina by 3 over EAST CAROLINA - SC has won the L/4 mtgs including in Muschamp's first year ('16) when the Gamecocks were only -3, but were outgained 519-312 but won 20-15. Similar situation here as SC again has a bran new HC in Shane Beamer. QB Doty was injured in camp so Beamer turned to former grad asst Zeb Noland who only had a 5-6 ratio (51%) in 6 starts at North Dakota St last year and was at Iowa St previously. Noland led SC to a 46-0 (-31) win over FCS Eastern Illinois last week. Doty could return this week but Noland did throw 4 td's and SC was even missing LY's SEC leading rusher Harris who could be back this week. East Carolina enters off a 33-19 (+10) loss against App State. The Pirates led 6-0 1Q but trailed 33-9 until adding 10 points in garbage time. East Carolina has wins over VTech (twice), NCSt and NCar (twice) since 2014 but the Gamecocks are going to be a fired up SEC team with something to prove as an underdog against a G5 school so we call for a small upset.

FAU by 9 over Georgia Southern - Last year was the first mtg and GA Southern won 20-3 but was +4 TO's and only had a 339-322 yd edge. FAU trailed 28-0 4Q last week in 'The Swamp' but scored 2 late td's including with 1:37 left for a backdoor cover, losing 35-14 (+23). Miami transfer N'Kosi Perry got his first start at FAU and hit 19-23-261-1-0. GA Southern was -28 last week but only beat FCS Gardner-Webb 30-25. The Eagles played 2 QB's last week including Amari Jones who actually played RB at Tulane. They did have a 263-109 yd edge and led 20-6 at the half. FAU has a huge edge in experience with 20 starters back (#11 vs #107 exp). The Owls were gashed for 400 rush yards last week and last year allowed 269 (4.6) in this matchup but should be better prepared the 2nd time around. FAU is only 2-10 ATS in home openers and their struggles defending the run have us concerned but we think Taggart's offense will be more explosive with Perry under center and GSU just allowed 365 pass yards to Gardner Webb. FAU gets their revenge and wins by just over a td.

MINNESOTA by 27 over Miami, Oh - Minnesota is 3-0 all-time vs. the Redhawks (covered L/2). The Golden Gophers led 14-10 at HT over #4 OSU. Mo Ibrahim had 30-163 before going down late in the 3Q and leaving the stadium in a walking boot (check status). Their offense stalled with Ibrahim out of the game and the defense gave up big plays as OSU won 45-31 (-14). Miami is coming off a rivarly-game with Cincinnati in which they were thoroughly dismantled on the road, trailing 42-0 in the 4Q before falling 49-14 (+22'), giving us our first Early Bird Winner of the season (Free on Button Mondays, #9, call 1-347-677-1700). They now head into B10 country to face the most exp'd team in the nation. Minnesota is 7-3-1 ATS vs non-conf foes while Miami is 2-12. Minnesota QB Tanner Morgan was efficient against the Buckeyes and can repeat his performance, even in the absence of Ibrahim. The Redhawks were without the '19 MAC Freshman of the Year QB Brett Gabbert (inj'd, check status) last week. If Gabbert returns, Miami could keep this a little closer with Minn looking ahead to Colorado next week but our line is Gophers by nearly 4 td's.

OKLAHOMA ST by 8 over Tulsa - These in-state foes have met 76 times, with OSU holding a 43-28-5 edge & have won 8 straight in the series dating back to '99. Teams met LY in the opener and prior to that game OSU had covered the previous 4 meetings, but OSU (-23') QB Sanders went down with an inj early and Tulsa led 7-3 HT. In the 2H Tulsa was held to 75 yds and OSU won 16-7. OSU only won 23-16 (-32) vs Missouri St last week while Tulsa was missing some key players due to susp incl 4 st's and fell to UC Davis 19-17. Those players should be back & overall Tulsa returns 18 st's & RB Brooks (1046, 4.6 in '19) returns after missing LY with an ACL inj. OSU returns 13 st's and lost their top RB and top 2 WR's but have dual threat QB Sanders back, however Sanders had to miss last week due to COVID protocols (CS). Tulsa must replace QB Smith, but Davis Brin has some exp & has all 5 starting OL back along with all starting WR's from LY. Tulsa's D was strong LY as they held foes to 333 ypg & 88 ypg under their ssn avg (#7). OSU was just 1-3-1 ATS LY as home chalk, while Tulsa is 8-2 the L3Y as a DD underdog & are 6-1 ATS as a road dog the L3Y. We feel like Tulsa will bounce back & hang in there with OSU just like they did last season.

Rutgers by 3 over SYRACUSE - Former Big East rivals meet again for the first time since 2012. Rutgers won 6 of the last 8 meetings (6-2 ATS). Cuse is 7-1 SU/5-3 ATS in home openers and their only win last year was when they opened the Carrier Dome with a 37-20 upset win over GTech. Rutgers put up a deceiving 61 points last week vs Temple but only finished with a 365-261 yd edge and were +5 TO's. The Scarlet Knights only led 26-14 3Q before the floodgates opened. Cuse looked much improved with a more stable Oline in last week's 29-9 (-1'). The Orange rushed for 283 yds but only threw for 100 and finished with just a +43 yd edge and Ohio settled for 4 fg attempts. Rutgers allowed just 261 yds including 113 rush while Cuse RB Sean Tucker ran for 181 (7.2). With both teams having deceiving wins, we will look to the coaches to decide our lean. HC Shiano has Rutgers improving each game and they were 4-0 as road dogs last year while Babers squad is 0-5 ATS off a SU win. Rutgers is an AF for the first time since '15. We are calling for Rutgers to get the win by a field goal and Schiano's squad did upset Mich St in their road opener last year.

VIRGINIA TECH by 15 over Middle Tennessee - First meeting. The Hokies enter off a huge upset win over ACC Coastal favorite North Carolina. The Hokies were outgained 354-296 but picked off 3 Sam Howell passes and won 17-10 (+6). Now the Hokies have to avoid an emotional letdown with West Virginia on deck. We were 2-0 in our Star rated Small College plays last week, including an easy 4★ winner on Middle Tenn who beat Monmouth 50-15 (-7). The Blue Raiders are an improved team with an ACC transfer at QB in Bailey Hockman (9 st, 2088, 64%, 13-11 LY), two Power-5 transfer RB's and 10 starters back on defense. VT has an obvious talent edge but Stockstill's squad won't be overwhelmed and this is a huge sandwich game for the Hokies. VT is 6-11 as chalk the last 2 years and MT did beat Cuse in their road opener in '17 and covered at Mich in '19. This line is a touch inflated after VT's upset win over NCar and we think MT can keep it closer than expected.

NEW MEXICO by 14 over New Mexico St - This will be the 111th meeting of the "Rio Grande Rivarly" and all-time New Mexico has a 72-33-5 lead. New Mexico has won 6 of the L/8 meetings SU but over the L/5 meetings The Lobos are just 1-4 ATS. The Lobos are in the 2nd year under HC Gonzales and bring back 17 st's (8 OFF/9 DEF). At QB the Lobos added UK transfer Terry Wilson, who went 20-26 for 174 yds (3 td) in his NMex debut last wk against FCS Houston Baptist. NMex did hold HOU Baptist to -9 rush yds and collected 5 sks! NMST is off to an 0-2 start, but last week did hold a 10-0 lead over SDSU, but were shutout in the 2H and lost 28-10. NMST QB Johnson threw for 326 yds last wk vs one of the better secondaries in the MW & now faces a NMex pass D that finished #122 last ssn. NMST's offense looks to be improved, but the OL has all'd 8 sks in 2 gms. NMST's run defense has also struggled early, as they have all'd 226 rush ypg (5.4) & NMex has a solid rush attack. NMex is just 4-9 ATS dating back to '17 against non-conf foes while NMST is 4-10 ATS as an away dog since '18. NMex did only beat an FCS foe by 10 pts last week, and we were impressed by NMST last week & think they can keep this gm right around 2 TD's.

NOTRE DAME by 21 over Toledo - First meeting. The Irish have won 9 straight home openers (6-1 ATS). Notre Dame is 4-0 SU & 2-1-1 ATS vs MAC teams s/2010. ND destroyed MAC foe Bowling Green 52-0 (-45) in '18 but only got by Ball St 24-16 (-34') in '18. Rockets are just 1-4 SU & ATS vs P5 teams since 2014 but did upset #18 Arkansas 16-12 in 2015. Toledo returns 21 starters from last year while ND returns just 9. Still as you would expect ND has the edges on both Offense (328-#80) & Defense (#9-#72). Toledo opened the season with an easy 49-10 win over Norfolk St but failed to cover as a 39' pt HF. While they only finished with a 441-272 yd edge, part of that was due to returning 2 blocked punts for TD's. UT's OLine struggled allowing 3 sacks LW which will be a concern against ND's defense that had 4 sacks in the 1H last week. The Irish are off a Sunday night 41-38 OT win at Florida St as a 7 pt AF. The Irish took an 18 pt lead in the 3Q but allowed Florida St to battle back & send the game into OT. QB Coen threw for a ND season opener record 366 yds (4 td) in his debut but ND was outgained 442-431. ND has in-state Purdue on deck as they will renew the rivalry for the first time since 2014. The Rockets have a home game vs Colorado St on deck. While Toledo can be dangerous, ND has covered 4 straight vs non-P5 tms the L/2 yrs incl 3 as a favorite of 24+ pts incl a 52-0 win (-24) over USF LY.

Purdue by 30 CONNECTICUT - First meeting. Huskies are 9-11 SU & 12-7-1 ATS vs Big Ten teams since 2001. They hosted Big Ten foe Illinois in 2019 losing 31-23 but covering as a 21' pt HD. After becoming a Independent in 2020, the Huskies canceled their season due to Covid. They have actually already played 2 games this year but both were disappointing. They opened as a 27' pt AD at Fresno St & lost 45-0 being outgained 538-107. Last week they hosted FCS foe Holy Cross, who

was the Patriot League Champ in the Spring season, making the FCS playoffs. UConn led HC 14-7 into the 2Q but then threw a pick 6. They trailed 24-21 at HT & 31-28 into 4Q & then threw INT's on their 20 4Q possessions. The Huskies were outgained 363-262. Purdue opened the season with a 30-21 win over Oregon St as a 7 pt HF. They trailed OSU 7-0 1Q. After taking a 10-7 2Q lead, never trailed but were up just 23-21 w/3:13 left but went 75 yds in 4 plays to seal the win & front door cover scoring a td w/2:09 left but only finished with a 401-363 yd edge. As you would expect Purdue hold the edge on both Offense (#43-#129) & Defense (#54-#129). Purdue has opened as a 33 pt AF & the last 2 times they were a favorite of 30+ was in 2010 & 2008 both vs FCS foes & while they won both the covered neither. Add in a trip Notre Dame on deck for the Boilermakers and that seems just a bit too much even with UConn's struggles. UConn HC Edsall also announced that he will be retiring after the season, which could give them an emotional surge.

Air Force by 1 over NAVY - This game was moved up to be played on the 20th anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks. All-time AF holds a 31-22 lead & the tms have traded wins over the L/8 mtgs with the home team going 8-0 SU/7-1 ATS. Last season AF played Navy in their opening game with some key players absent & Navy had 2 gms under their belt, but AF rolled to a 40-7 as they held Navy to 241 yds. Air Force is off their opening game vs FCS Lafayette where they won 35-14 & as a team ran for 340 yds. Their rush attack was led by RB Roberts (111) and WR Davis, who had 101 yds on just 4 att (2 td's). Navy ret'd 14 st's this ssn & with a full offseason they looked to rebound from a 3-7 record LY. However they fell to Marshall LW 49-7. However Navy rushed for 337 yds & held the ball for over 41 min, plus they had both a FG and a punt blocked in the 1H. Air Force lost several players LY to turnbacks, mainly on defense & those players are back this season including LB's Meeks and Wills along with DE Jackson. Navy is on a 7-4-1 ATS run as a HD, while AF is just 4-10 as road chalk since 2016 and the home team has pulled off 3 straight outright upsets in the series.

PENN ST by 18 over Ball St - 1st ever meeting. Ball St (-31) was outplayed by FCS Western Illinois in the 1H LW. WIU held a 9-6 FD edge at the break by outgaining the Cardinals 182-131. Ball St was outgained by 33 yds for the game, allowing 437 total yds of offense to the Leathernecks, including 367 yds passing. WR Dennis Houston scorched the Cardinals' defense for 237 receiving yds. Penn St is sandwiched in-between Power 5 opponents Wisconsin and Auburn, but have won by 53 & 56 points in their previous two Power-5 sandwich situations. The Nittany Lions are coming off an outright upset win in Madison after beating the Badgers 16-10 (+5'). Ball St does have the 14th most exp'd tm in the country compared to the 99th most exp'd for Penn St. Ball St's 20 returning starters, including QB Drew Plitt (2,164, 66%, 17/6 LY), clearly looked ahead to Penn St as the reigning MAC champs feel they can compete with the B10's upper echelon and are 5-1 ATS L2Y as AD. We expect much better from the Cardinals this week and feel they can keep the game within 3 scores.

Temple by 3 over AKRON - Temple is 14-7 all-time vs Akron, having won the last 5 meetings, with the final two by a combined score of 71-3. LTH the Owls led 28-3 after 1H (+15') and shutout the Zips 13-0 after the break in a 41-3 rout. Temple has won the L4 meetings by at least 21 pts. Sr. QB Kato Nelson was OFY in '20, but returns with the opportunity become Akron's 2nd all-time leading passer if he remains healthy (5,138, 52%, 34/16). D'wan Mathis (PS#12) transferred from Georgia and takes over for an offense that was outgained by an average of 85 ypg LY. The Zips however were outgained by an average of 179 ypg in '20 and are 3-15 ATS with 1 win SU since '19. Akron was handled 60-10 by Auburn on the road (+37') LW while being outgained by 424 yds. Temple was down 26-14 early 3Q LW to Rutgers (+14'), but the Scarlet Knights used 5 Owl TO's to run away with the game 61-14 despite just 365 yds of total offense. Akron is 0-8 as an HD but Temple is 1-3 as an AF and we think the Zips will be much more competitive this year.

GEORGIA by 21 over Uab - Georgia has won 9 straight home openers and is 2-0 all-time vs UAB though the last meeting was in 2006, well before Bill Clark turned UAB into a CUSA powerhouse. The Blazers enter off an impressive 37-0 (-16') win over FCS Jacksonville St on a neutral field and had a 363 yd edge. Georgia has to find the emotional energy after upsetting Clemson 10-3 last week. The Dawgs vaunted D held Clemson to just 180 yards including only 2 rush yards and finished with 7 sacks!!! The only td in the entire game came from a UGA pick 6 by Christopher Smith. Bill Clark is only 1-4 as an AD and 0-4 SU/ATS vs Power 5 foes but the Blazers clearly catch UGA in a letdown spot and the Dawgs have their SEC opener against South Carolina on deck. UGA has a big edge on offense but UAB actually has a top 30 defense, only allowing 311 ypg last year with 9 starters back and some NFL talent. UAB is only 1-4 as an AD and Clark's struggles vs P5 foes tell us that he is far more concerned with their CUSA opener next week so we only give UAB a small lean.

IOWA ST by 6 over Iowa - 68th battle for the CyHawk Trophy & Iowa leads the series 45-22. Recently Iowa has dominated the series as they are 6-1 SU/4-2-1 ATS since 2013, but 5 of the last 7 mtgs have been decided by 10 pts or less. Iowa St brings back a talented squad with 20 st's (#29 experience) back led by QB Purdy, RB Hall on offense and LB Rose and DE McDonald on defense. Iowa ranks lower on the experience chart (#112) as they have 14 st's back led by QB Petras. Iowa won 34-6 last week against B10 over Indiana but only outgained them 303-323 as 14 pts for Iowa came off 2 INT's returned for TD's. Iowa St played FCS Northern Iowa last week and trailed 7-0 early & only won the game 16-7. ISU did not have AA TE Kolar (ankle) but it sounds like he should be back this wk. Iowa St is just 6-11 ATS as home chalk since 2018, and with both team having a strong defense we see this game ending within one score. However we lean slightly with ISU as the opening line is only around a FG. ISU is more exp'd and are slightly better on both sides of the ball, plus they will have the home field edge. One interesting note for this gm is that the 'UNDER' has hit in 14 of the previous 16 meetings.

† Texas A&M by 24 over Colorado - Former Big 12 foes meet at Empower Field at Mile High Stadium in Denver. The Buffs were -38' last week vs FCS Northern Colorado but only led 21-7 4Q and finished w/ a 383-256 yd edge. Frosh QB Brendon Lewis got his first career start and threw for just 102 yards. Now he faces one of the top defenses in the country that returns 9 starters from a unit that allowed just 21.7 ppg against an all-SEC schedule. The Aggies only led Kent St 10-3 at half but did have a 273-165 yd edge. A&M held KSt QB Dustin Crum to just 89 yards (46% with 2 int's including a pick 6. Frosh QB Haynes King threw for 292 but had 3 int's. We look for a much cleaner game from King this week and A&M should be able to run the ball against a Buffs D that allowed 303 ypg (7.6). Colo did allow just 20 rush yds LW but that was against a FCS squad that didn't play LY and hasn't ran for 4.0 ypc in their last 3 seasons. A&M only has New Mexico on deck so this will be a full effort and HC Fisher is 6-0 as an AF and 9-2 ATS vs non-conference foes at A&M.

Houston by 9 over RICE - This is a bitter rivarly between two schools only separated by 4 miles, and Houston leads the all-time series 31-11. The Cougs have won 5 straight dating back to '11. Houston has averaged 44 ppg during the streak, with only one of those wins coming by less than 3 scores. LTH, Houston trailed 24-17 on the road (-25') after the 1H. Rice only managed a FG in the 2H however and lost 45-27. The Owls did add Nebraska transfer Luke McCaffrey (PS#22) at QB and were upset-minded LY, having pulled off two outright, including a 20-pt shutout of undefeated and 15th ranked Marshall as 22-pt AD. HC Mike Bloomgren has increased Rice's win % in each of his three seasons at the helm, but they are sandwiched between two other old Southwest Conference foes in Arkansas and Texas, while the Cougars have the FCS's Grambling St on deck. Houston led 14-0 LW vs. TT before Tech's offense ever took the field but lost 38-21 (-2). Rice led Arkansas 17-7 midway through 3Q before the Razorbacks pulled away 38-17 (+19'). We expect that Rice can keep this game within single digits.

Washington +6 over MICHIGAN

These two last met in '02, the Huskies are 4-2 SU/ATS in the previous 6 mtgs. Mich reestablished the run game under new RBs coach and the school's all-time leading rusher, Mike Hart, churning out 335 yds on the ground while averaging nearly 8 ypc in a 47-14 blowout win at the Big House over WMich (-16'). The Wolverines outgained the Broncos by 234 total yds. WR Ronnie Bell registered a 76-yd TD catch but hurt his right knee during a PR in the 2Q and is OFY, and his status remains uncertain. The Wolverines are just 4-9 ATS vs non-conf foes since '17. Washington was stunned at home by FCS Montana LW 13-7 (-22'), but held a 14-2 FD edge in the 1H. Costly TOs and glancing ahead to their trip to Ann Arbor had the Huskies overlooking an inferior opponent. We expect a big bounce back and for Washington to win by a field goal.

MIAMI, FL by 7 over Appalachian St - These two met in '16 when Miami was only -3' on the road but cruised to a 45-10 win but that win came after 2 easy blowouts, this time the 'Canes are in a huge sandwich, coming off a blowout loss at Bama with a better than expected Michigan St squad on deck. The 'Canes were no match for Bama, losing 44-13 (+19') and was outgained 501-266. App St was impressive in their opener, beating East Carolina 33-19. The Mountaineers actually led 33-9 4Q and EC's last td came with just 2:10 left. QB Chase Brice has ACC starting experience from his time at both Duke and Clemson. He threw 15 int's LY at Duke but did look more confident last week, hitting 20-27-259-2-1. App St has covered 4 of their L/6 vs Power-5 foes including an upset win over North Carolina in '19. We can't see Miami starting 0-2 but Diaz is only 3-9 ATS with 5 upset losses when the 'Canes are favored by 7+ points and App St actually has a slight defensive edge here, plus the Mountaineers have covered 5 of their L/7 as dogs.

Texas St by 1 over FIU - First time meeting between these SBC and CUSA foes. TXSt brings back '17 st'rs and are in HC Spavital's 3rd season. Last week TXSt never led, but hung around with Baylor, as they only lost 29-20. INT's doomed TXSt last week as QB McBride threw 3 incl a pick-six. FIU has 18 st'rs back this season and are led by veteran HC Butch Davis. They got their season off to a 1-0 start after taking care of business 48-10 against FCS Long Island. Neither teams defense was veeey good LY as TXSt gave up 495 ypg & FIU allowed 423 ypg, but neither team had an overly impressive offense LY either. FIU does have experience back at QB as well as receiver & they face a TXSt pass D that finished #121 LY, but did allow just 148 yds last week vs Baylor. TXSt's OL did hold up well against a Baylor defense as they all'd just 1 sk in 40 pass att last week & here they face an exp'd DLine but it is a few steps down from Baylor. FIU is just 6-11 ATS the L5Y as a home favorite. TXSt comes in as just 4-7 ATS under Spavital as an away underdog, but we like the talent TXSt has and think they go to FIU and pull off a narrow victory.

Nc State by 6 over MISSISSIPPI ST - The last 3 meetings between these 2 have come in bowls including in '16's Belk Bowl when the Bulldogs won 51-28 (-4'). We grabbed a Marquee winner on NCSt last week in their 45-0 blowout win over USF. The Pack ran for 293 yards with RB Knight going for 163 and Person adding 105. We also had a 2★ winner on these pages going against heavily favored Miss St against LA Tech. Miss St trailed 34-14 before scoring 3 td's in the final 12:01 and LT missed a GW fg. Miss St finished with 436-369 yd & 22-14 FD edges but was -4 TO's. QB Rogers threw for 370 and completed 83%. NCSt's pass D will be tested after giving up over 400 yds twice last year but they returned all 4 starting DB's. NCSt is just 1-7 SU/ATS vs SEC schools since 2008 but they did pull 2 road upsets last year and Leach is 0-5 ATS in Starkville. We actually think NCSt has the edge in all 3 phases so we like the Wolfpack by a field goal.

WISCONSIN by 20 over Eastern Michigan - Excluding their MAC-only schedule in '20, EMU has notched an outright upset against a B10 opponent on the road L3Y (Rutgers, Purdue, Illinois). Eastern Michigan is 4-0 ATS in road openers, and while they are 0-3 all-time against Wisconsin SU, they are 2-1 ATS. EMU has 21 starters returning, including QB Preston Hutchinson (1,662/64%/12/6 LY). The Eagles are coming off a decent 20-pt win as 34-pt HF against St. Francis (PA) but have a trip to UMASS on deck. The Badgers will have a bye week before their showdown with ND and are hungry to rebound after an outright upset loss at home against Penn St (+5'). Wisconsin is 14-20-1 ATS as HF under HC Paul Chryst. The Eagles should keep the game right at 4 TDs and how can you go against EM who is 19-3 as an AD!

SMU by 27 over North Texas - These teams have met every yr since '14, and SMU have won 5 of the L/6 mtgs. The Mean Green have not won in Dallas since 1933, having lost 15 straight and 24 of the last 25. LTH the Mustangs were -3' but led 21-0 after the 1Q and won 49-27 LY. SMU racked up 710 total yds and 65 pts on the road (-14) and won in a rout, 65-35. NT is 2-5 ATS since '19 as AD, while SMU is 7-2 ATS vs non-conf since '19. SMU QB Tanner Mordeci threw for 317 yds and a school-rec 7 TDs against FCS Abilene Christian in a decisive 56-9 rout (-32). NT RB DeAndre Torrey gained nearly 10 ypc vs FCS NWSL LW, piling up 244 yds on 25 rushes. The Mean Green won 44-14 (-20), but allowed 418 total yds of offense to an FCS opponent. North Texas was outgained by an average of 9 ypg LY, while SMU was +72 ypg. We think SMU will win by more than 3 TDs.

Liberty by 9 over TROY - 4th meeting between these schools, but only 1 has come with both teams as FBS foes. That meeting came in 2018 when Troy traveled to Liberty as 9-pt favorites but Liberty held them to just 293 yds and they pulled the outright upset, winning 22-16. Liberty & their star QB Willis got off to a 1-0 start as they easily won 48-7 (537-269, +10 FD's) vs FCS Campbell, while Troy also picked up an easy win, beating FCS Southern 55-3 (464-189, +3 TO's). Chip Lindsey's Trojans bring back 18 st'rs including 10 on defense. Troy does return QB Watson from last season, but he was beat out by Missouri transfer Taylor Powell for the starting job. Troy does have an exp'd defense returning, but they did allow 67% completions LY & now they face one of the top playmaking QB's in the country. Lib's D returns 9 st'rs from a unit that gave up 318 ypg/20 ppg LY. Liberty does have a good pass rush as well led by DE Durrell Johnson (8.5 sk LY). LU is 3-1 ATS under HC Freeze as road chalk & we like the Flames to go on the road & come away with the win.

Memphis by 8 over ARKANSAS ST - The Tigers lead the all-time series 30-23-5. LY Memphis hosted the Red Wolves and won 37-24 in the ssn opening game for both teams (-18'). Memphis rolled at home LW to a 42-17 win over FCS Nicholls (-22'), racking up 587 yds of total offense with a 32-17 FD edge. ASt hosted FCS Central Arkansas and came away with a 40-21 victory (-13'). The Red Wolves outgained the Bears by 175 yds and finished with a 25-15 FD edge. While they held the yd edge and FD edge in the 1H, Arkansas St actually trailed their FCS foes 7-6 at HT. The Red Wolves are just 8-14 ATS vs non-conf opponents since '16. While Memphis has a big game on deck, hosting Mississippi St, ASt has a cross-country trip to PAC-12 contender Washington looming. While we think this game will be fairly close to the line, we expect Memphis to win by just over a TD.

Texas by 4 over ARKANSAS - Ark has won 3 of the 5 meetings since the Hogs left the SWC. Texas won Sarkisian's debut last week in their 38-18 (-8') win over Louisiana. The Horns did only finish with a 435-358 yd edge and allowed 70% completions and 282 pass yds. Last week Ark was the chalk for the first time under Sam Pittman. Rice led 17-7 3Q, and it was still tied in the 4Q. Ark (-19') added 3 td's including with just :58 left for the front door cover. The Hogs revert back to their much preferred role as the underdog here. Ark was -60 ypg last year while Texas was +69 ypg and +103 ypg at

home. The Hogs were 7-3 as dogs last year but only 1 of their upsets came on the road. Sarkisian did face Pittman's D last year when he was OC at Bama. We think Ark was caught looking ahead to this game so we don't mind taking the home dog to keep it close.

NORTH CAROLINA by 31 over Georgia St - Georgia St gets their first meeting vs NCar at a bad time with the Heels coming off a season opening loss at Virginia Tech 17-10. QB Howell looks to have a bounce back performance after he only hit 17-32 with 3 int's against the Hokies. NCar did hold VT to under 300 yards and finished with a +58 yd edge. Georgia St struggled to defend the triple option in last week's 43-10 (+2) loss to Army. GSt fell behind 21-0 2Q and was held to just 177 yards. Their defense allowed 410 ypg including 274 through the air last year and Sam Howell should have a big bounce back performance. The Heels have a big game vs UVA on deck but won't hold back here and they are 9-1 SU/8-2 ATS in home openers and HC Brown is 7-3 ATS when favored by double-digits. Last year NCar was 3-0 ATS off a SU loss with wins by 40, 32 & 27 so we don't mind laying big points on the angry Tar Heels.

COLORADO ST by 6 over Vanderbilt - This is the first meeting. CSU is 3-15 SU all-time against SEC foes, but their last win against an SEC team came back in 2018 when they hosted Arkansas & won 34-27 as nearly 2 TD underdogs (+13'). Vanderbilt last played a Mountain West foe back in 2019 where they faced UNLV (-15) at home but ended up getting upset 34-10. Both teams did not get off to good starts to the 2021 season. CSU fell to S.Dakota St 42-23 (462-466, -2 TO's) at home while Vandy managed to commit as many TO's as points scored (3) and fell to E.Tenn St by 20 points at home. CSU brought back 19 st'rs this season, but did lose QB O'Brien. Todd Centeio is the new QB & is a dual-threat guy. CSU's biggest offensive weapon is TE Trey McBride & last wk he had 13 rec for 116 yds. As a single-digit dog Vandy is just 2-8 ATS since '17. While neither team was impressive last week, we'll give a slight edge to CSU as Vandy has to battle the elevation.

San Diego St by 8 over ARIZONA - Arizona leads the all-time series 10-5 and have won 4 straight meetings, however the last meeting came back in 2001. SDSt comes off a 28-10 win at home vs New Mex St, where they did trail 10-0 at HT before shutting down NMSt in the 2H. AZ is in a loss against BYU in Las Vegas. Despite having the yds edge (426-368) and the FD edge (27-18) the Wildcats did fall 24-16 but QB Cruz looked impressive with 336 yds & he hit 75% of his throws. SDSt's typically stingy defense didn't have their best game last week as they all'd 374 yds to NMSt incl 326 pass yds and AZ threw for 345 yds last week! SDSt's run D was stout as usual, giving up just 48 yds (1.8) and AZ ran for only 81 yds (2.3) last week. AZ does have 17 st'rs back. 1st year HC Fisch there could be a lot of moving parts in the lineup, while SDSt is #45 in exp (Ariz is #91). SDSt is 5-2 ATS against P12 foes incl pulling 3 outright upsets. Another number to look for here is SDSt has gone "UNDER" in 18 of their 22 previous games, meaning they keep a lot of gms close. We will call for them to pull off another win vs a Pac-12 foe.

Utah by 9 over BYU - The "Holy War", last year was just the 2nd time since 1946 that these rivals did not play. Utah has won the last 9 vs BYU going 6-3 ATS. LTH ("19) which was also the last meeting The Utes won 30-12 as a 6' pt AF despite having just a 368-300 yd edge as Utah had 3 TD's off BYU TO's including 2 IR TD's. The Utes has a couple of extra days to prepare as they opened the season this past Thursday, with a 40-17 win as a 28' pt HF over Weber St. They actually trailed 7-3 after allowing a 100 yd KR td & were up 19-10 in 3Q. The Cougars opened the season in Las Vegas with 24-16 (-12') win over P12 foe Arizona. BYU led that game 21-3 but after a great Arizona punt downed at the 1, BYU allowed a safety & then a td 1:12 later to led the Wildcats back in the game & were outgained 426-368. BYU had to replace QB Wilson (#1 DC) & Jaren Hall was Solit hitting 18-28-198-2-0. Utah return 19 starters while BYU returns just 11. The Utes also have the edges on both Offense (#29-#42) & Defense (#19-#65) and should make it 10 straight over the Cougars.

ARIZONA ST by 36 over UNlv - Only prior meeting was back in 2008 when UNLV went into Tempe as 24-pt underdogs and pulled off the 23-20 upset in overtime. Both teams played last Thursday so had a couple extra days to prep for this meeting. The Rebels are off an opening week loss to FCS Eastern Washington where they fell 35-33 in 2OT and were outgained by 132 yds. Ariz St had no issues with Southern Utah, as they won 41-14 and had a 421-224 yd edge. UNLV played QB's last week and while Brumfield looked better than J.Rogers, QB is still a huge question mark for the Rebels. UNLV's best offensive threat is RB Charles Williams who ran for 172 yds (6.4, 2 td). Ariz St has 20 st'rs back (9 OFF/11 DEF) and on offense are led by QB Daniels while their defense brings back their top 15 tk!r's Ariz St is just 1-6 ATS the L3Y as a home favorite while UNLV is just 1-6 ATS overall under HC Arroyo. Ariz St does have a road gm next week at BYU, but with the shape UNLV is in right now, we cannot justify leaning with them in any scenario.

USC by 13 over Stanford - USC is 3-1 SU against Stanford and has covered 2 of the last 3. These two didn't meet last year, with USC winning the last mtg in '19 45-20 (-3). The Trojans were +47 ypg last year and got 16 starters back including QB Slovis. Stanford was -19 ypg last year but did win their L/4 games including 3 outright upsets and brought back 14 starters. They did have to replace their QB and things didn't go well in their opener vs Kansas St. The Cardinal were missing their 2 starting S's and were outgained 344-233 in a 24-7 (+3) where they used 2 QB's and fell behind 24-0. The Trojans ended a streak of 5 straight non covers in season openers by beating San Jose St 30-7 (-14). USC only had a +40 yd edge and only led 13-7 4Q when a pick 6 broke the game open. We think the Trojans have solid edges in all 3 phases so we don't mind calling for USC to win by DD's.

OREGON ST by 7 over Hawaii - Overall these teams have met 11 times with OSU holding a 7-4 series edge. However the last time these teams met was back in 2019 at Hawaii and the Rainbow Warriors (-6') came away with a 31-28 win. Hawaii has 2 games under their belt and after losing to UCLA 44-10 in the opener they rebounded with a 49-35 win at home against FCS Portland St. Oregon St opened the season at Purdue with a 30-21 loss. The Beavers have 10 st'rs back on offense but QB Gebbia DNP last wk and his status is unknown as of presstime. Sam Noyer and Chance Nolan split reps last week & comb'd to throw for over 250 yds. OSU is in a rare role as a HF. While Hawaii's D is still a question mark we feel like Hawaii should be able to keep this game within single digits.

Following a disappointing home loss in LY's NFC Championship, GB takes on a Saints squad that won't have Drew Brees starting under center for the 1st time since '05. In the Packers' Wk 3 trip to the Superdome LY, Aaron Rodgers would throw for 283 yds & 3 TD's in the 37-30 victory (+3). With the Saints notoriously having rocky beginnings to their ssn's (1-6 ATS in Wk 1) and dealing with a neutral matchup instead of having a pumped up crowd inside of the Superdome, we like GB (5-1 ATS in Wk 1) to pick up the win and cover in this one. **FORECAST: Green Bay by 12**

3★ NEW ENGLAND over Miami - The Dolphins were a win away from earning a WC spot LY while NE's 7-9 mark in '20 was their worst since going 5-11 in 2000! MIA and NE have split their ssn series in each of the past 4 yrs incl MIA's 22-12 win (-1) late in '20. While MIA is 8-4 ATS as both an AD and against DIV foes, NE 11-4-1 ATS as DIV home chalk. With NE also covering 4 of their L/5 home openers incl a 21-11 (-7) win over MIA LY in Foxboro, we'll go ahead and call for rookie starting QB Mac Jones to get their '21 campaign off to a solid start (MIA was outgained in 6 of their 8 road contests LY). **FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ WASHINGTON over La Chargers - The Chargers head East for a 2nd consecutive season opener after narrowly escaping Cincy in '20 (16-13 win). WAS meanwhile was one of the NFL's biggest surprises last year by claiming a DIV title in the porous NFC East. The Chargers have won 4 of the last 5 in the series including a 30-13 home victory in '17 where they finished with significant FD (24-9) and yard (488-201) edges. While LAC is also 5-2-2 ATS in road openers, WAS did cover 6 of their L/7 regular season contests a season ago and should pull off the small home upset here behind one of the NFL's top defensive units (all'd just 20.6 ppg and 305 ypg last year). **FORECAST: WASHINGTON by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

Dallas at TAMPA BAY - Thursday - The Bucs return to action as the 1st defending champ since 1979 to bring back all 22 starters while the Cowboys are expected to get the healthy return of QB Dak Prescott who missed the final 11 a year ago with injury. In their most recent meeting back in '18, the Cowboys knocked off the Bucs for the 7th time in 8 tries despite 27-16 FD and 383-232 yard deficits. While TB is just 7-19-2 ATS as a NDIV HF coming in, something will have to give in this one as the Cowboys have failed to cover 11 of their past 16 contests. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

BUFFALO by 10 over Pittsburgh - Following a rough end to LY where they dropped 5 of their L/6 including a playoff loss to DIV rival CLE, the Steelers head to BUF on just a 2-7-1 ATS run in season openers and with a handful of new players on both sides of the ball (OL is a huge ?). The Bills meanwhile were a win away from their 1st SB appearance in 28 years thanks in part to the #2 scoring offense in the NFL (31.3 ppg). While the Steelers had won 9 of 10 in the series from '94-'16, the Bills have now cashed 2 straight including a 26-15 home victory LY where they finished with 21-14 FD and 334-224 yard edges. With BUF having covered 8 straight regular season contests coming in and cashing 6 of their L/8 matchups in Wk 1, we have no issue giving them the DD edge in this one.

CAROLINA by 7 over Ny Jets - Well it didn't take long for former 1st Rnd DC Sam Darnold to take on his old team as he welcomes the Jets in Charlotte after spending his 1st 3 years in the "Big Apple". The Jets meanwhile are breaking in a brand new 1st Rnd DC at QB in BYU's Zach Wilson who led the Cougars to an impressive 11-1 mark a season ago. The Panthers have won the last 2 matchups in this series (1-0-1 ATS) including a 35-27 (-5) road win in '17 (NYJ 391-299 yd edge). While we do like the hiring of HC Robert Saleh, the Jets' 4-9 ATS mark as an AD coming in has us leaning with the home squad here.

Jacksonville by 4 over HOUSTON - The Jaguars head on the road for the debut of HC Urban Meyer and QB Trevor Lawrence to take on a Texans squad that's come out victorious in each of the last 6 meetings (4-2 ATS). The Jags have been a DIV AF on just 3 occasions the past 10 years going a perfect 3-0 ATS in that span. With the expected struggles in HOU for '21 along with their 5-13 ATS mark as a HD and failing to cover 5 of their past 6 home openers, the visitor gets the small lean as they've covered 4 straight road openers coming in.

Arizona by 3 over TENNESSEE - The Titans enter the '21 season seeking a playoff berth for the 4th time in 5 seasons with some added weapons on the offensive side of the ball (WR Julio Jones). The Cardinals meanwhile just missed out on the postseason LY but also added some familiar names including former DPOY JJ Watt. ARZ has picked up 2 consecutive wins over the Titans including a 12-7 low-scoring affair in '17 where they finished with a 261-204 yard edge. While the Cardinals are 10-3 ATS in road openers, they did struggle ATS late in '20 having covered just 2 of their L/9. Despite their rough finish a year ago, we expect the Cardinals to go into Nashville and pick up the mild upset as the Titans have failed to cover 4 of their L/5 home openers while also finishing LY as one of the worst defenses in the NFL (all'd 27.4 ppg & 398 ypg).

ATLANTA by 2 over Philadelphia - A pair of teams that finished in the basement of their respective divisions LY face off here as PHI heads South having failed to cover 6 of their L/8 as an AD. ATL meanwhile has also struggled in their role as a NDIV HF having gone just 7-18 ATS. The Falcons (+1) ended a 3-game losing skid in their last meeting with the Eagles in '19 finishing with a 367-286 yardage edge. Despite their success in that recent meeting with the Eagles, ATL has failed to cover 5 straight season openers which should allow PHI to stay within a FG in this one.

INDIANAPOLIS by 3 over Seattle - The Seahawks travel East having gone just 3-10-1 ATS in road openers. The Colts meanwhile have clearly struggled in overall Wk 1 matchups having covered just 2 of their L/13 contests. In their most recent matchup back in '17, the Seahawks (-13) picked up an easy 46-18 victory with a 477-237 yard advantage. With the newly added Carson Wentz ? here for IND (pressn foot surgery), the opening line has seen an expected move in favor of the Seahawks (SEA +2 to SEA -2). With the Colts still a solid 10-2-1 ATS against NFC foes and 10-3 ATS as a NDIV HD, we'll count on their defense to slow down the Seahawks just enough to get the mild upset.

Minnesota by 3 over CINCINNATI - The Vikings head to CIN having gone 7-3 ATS as an AF while the Bengals are 5-2-1 ATS when listed as a HD. The Vikings and Bengals have split their past 6 meetings dating back to '95 with MIN picking up an easy 34-7 victory (18-8 FD & 346-161 yd edges) in their most recent matchup in '17. MIN is 19-9 ATS in recent meetings with the AFC, they have failed to cover 7 straight regular season games dating back to LY. With CIN getting QB Burrow back here and the Vikings looking like a trainwreck for most of the preseason, a FG lean is all that we can offer up for the visitor.

San Francisco by 10 over DETROIT - Following an injury-plagued year that saw them go from NFC Champs to just 6 regular season wins, the 49ers head into Ford Field having covered 11 of their L/16 as a NDIV AF. The Lions meanwhile also ended the '20 campaign in last place with a handful of changes being made TY including the arrival of HC Dan Campbell and QB Jared Goff. The 49ers have absolutely dominated this series dating back to 1988 with a 15-2 SU mark including a 30-27 home victory (-6) back in '18 (led 30-13 mid 3Q). With DET also on just a 2-7-1 ATS regular season run coming in, the visitor gets the DD win in this one.

In their most recent meeting back in '17, a winless Giants squad (+12) picked up a surprising 23-10 road upset despite the Broncos finishing with 20-12 FD and 412-266 yard edges (DEN -3 TO's). With DEN seeking some revenge from that surprise defeat along with the Giants' porous 1-7 ATS mark against the AFC, we have no issue giving the visitor the lean (NYG is just 4-14 ATS as a HD).

Chicago at LA RAMS - SNF - A battle of 2 playoffs squads from a year ago as the Bears head to LA to take on a Rams squad that's covered 6 consecutive home openers including a 20-17 (+2) win LY on SNF against the Cowboys. The Rams have come out victorious in each of the past 2 seasons including a 24-10 win (-6) LY on MNF where they had 24-14 FD and 371-279 yard edges. While we expect them to get another win this time around with Matthew Stafford under center, a TD+ point spread may be too much to cover against a solid Bears defense. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Baltimore at LAS VEGAS - MNF - The Ravens head to Vegas having covered 5 straight Wk 1 matchups where they've outscored their foes by a 35-5 clip! The Raiders meanwhile are on a 6-2 ATS run in Wk 1 including a shootout win over the Panthers LY in Charlotte. The Ravens have picked up wins in each of their L/2 meetings against the Raiders including a 34-17 home victory in '18 (23-13 FD & 416-249 yd edges). While BAL did cover their L/6 regular season contests a year ago, this will be the first time that the Raiders play in front of a packed home inside of their new stadium. 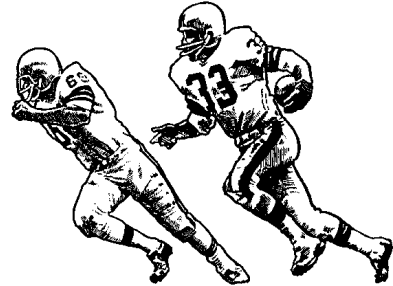
