HOME TEAM IN CAPS

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Tulsa (+) over SMU - TU is on a 4-1 SU/3-1 ATS series run & the visitor is 4-1 ATS. This is SMU's lone home game in a 4 week stretch & they have a bye on deck, but the Golden Hurricane enter fresh off a bye following their 24-21 (-3) win over Wyoming. This is TU's AAC opener. The Golden Hurricane hasn't beaten a ranked foe s/10 & the Ponies are ranked for the 1st time s/86. SMU is playing with revenge after entering LY's season finale 1 win away from becoming bowl eligible and losing 27-24 (-3). The Ponies enter 5-0 SU for the first time s/83 after their 48-21 (-7) blowout win at USF. SMU led 41-0 late 3Q & all'd 240 of the Bulls 342 tld yds on 3 td drives. The Ponies OFF, led by TX transfer QB Shane Buechele, has gained the most yds all'd by their L/4 foes & is #8 FBS avg 161 ypg more than their opponents allow. TU counters with our #12 ranked pass eff D, holding foes to 50% completions & all'd OKSt QB Sanders just 169 pass yds. TU is 15-8 as an AD & SMU will start to feel the pressure of being undefeated & ranked. **FORECAST: SMU by 6**
3★ North Carolina over GEORGIA TECH - GT has won the last 2 meetings. The home team is 11-5 SU/9-6-1 ATS. NC nearly pulled the upset of the year last week vs Clemson. The Tar Heels led for much of the 1H and only were down 21-14 4Q. Their td with 1:17 left would have tied the game but HC Mack Brown went for 2 unsuccessfully and the Heels lost 21-20 (+27). We picked up a 3★ winner LW going against Georgia Tech. GT (+8) lost by over 3 td's despite yards being nearly even and holding a FD edge. The Jackets managed just 2 pts but reached Temple territory on 5 occasions, with each ending in a SOD, fumble or int. NC is +11 ypg and has faced our #2 sked. GT is -102 ypg having faced our #41 sked. The Jackets are on an 0-7 ATS run and are 5-10 as a HD. We can't in good faith ride with the Jackets, who have yet to cover during their offensive transition and the Heels are full of confidence coming off their close loss to the Nat'l Champs. **FORECAST: North Carolina by 15**
3★ Auburn over FLORIDA - These two last met in 2011. Auburn has won 5 straight series meetings (4-1 ATS). The Tigers have flexed their muscles the last 2 weeks, upsetting A&M then crushing Miss St 56-23 (-10). QB Nix had his best game, throwing for 335 and rushing for 56. The Tigers stout run D held SEC's leading rusher Kylin Hill to 17-45. Florida enters off an easy 38-0 win over FCS Towson. The Tigers are +134 ypg while facing our #9 sked, avg 131 ypg more than their opponents allow (#13 in FBS) and hold opp's to 143 ypg less than their avg (#10 in FBS). UF is +151 ypg against our #87 sked. QB Trask hasn't seen a defensive line like Auburn's yet and the biggest ? for the Gators was their Oline entering '19. We've doubted Auburn all year, but they've covered 5 straight and already beat a ranked team on the road so it's time to hop on the Gus Bus. **FORECAST: Auburn by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ San Diego St over COLORADO ST - SDSt leads series 20-14. LTH ('15) SDSt (-3) came into Fort Collins and won 41-17. SDSt is fresh off a bye while CSU is off a road loss 34-24 at Utah St. While SDSt has not run the ball as well this ssn, they face a Rams D all'g 284 rush ypg vs FBS foes. Meanwhile the CSU OFF is avg'g 501 yds & 32 pts, but were held to just 296 yds vs USU LW will face an Aztec D all'g just 280 ypg & 12 ppg. CSU's RB Kinsey leads the MW w/ 626 rush yds but faces an Aztec run D all'g just 52 ypg! CSU is 0-6 ATS in their MW home opener while SDSt is 4-2 ATS in MW road openers. We'll back SDSt here as they are the superior team & are 8-3 ATS at CSU dating back to '92. **FORECAST: San Diego St by 14**

2★ UAB over Rice - UAB is 2-0 vs Rice winning by 31 & 42 pts. LY the Blazers held a +296 yd edge and shut the Owls out. UAB was +76 yds & +6 FD last week at WKU but lost by a touchdown. We like the job that Mike Bloomgren is doing at Rice, but it's hard to go against Bill Clark at home, where he is 11-2 ATS and UAB is allowing just 266 ypg incl just 80 (2.6) rush ypg. Rice is avg just 282 ypg and their OFF avg 109 ypg less than their opponents allow (#124 in nation). The Blazers are 5-1-1 ATS off a loss. **FORECAST: UAB by 17**

GS is off a home conf loss to Louisiana while SAla is off their SBC road opener, where they hung around w/ ULM in a 30-17 loss. SAla is all'g 218 rush ypg the L/3 wks & face a GS option that has avg'd 356 rush yds against them in 5 mtgs, while SAla's OFF has gained just 282 ypg vs FBS foes this ssn. GS will QB Werts for this one & RB Wesley Kennedy (502, 7.8 in '18) is back from a 4 gm susp. SAla is struggling to find consistent QB play and are 15-28-1 ATS at home since joining the FBS, while GS HC Lunsford is 11-6 ATS here and GS is 4-1 ATS in SBC road openers.

Temple at EAST CAROLINA - TU is 5-0 SU/ATS as AAC rivals, winning by 23 ppg & covering by 17 ppg! The Pirates have a bye on deck. LY EC trailed 35-3 at the half & lost 49-6 (+10). The Pirates snapped a 10 gm road losing streak after beating Old Dominion 24-21 (+3) last week, cashing our Top LPS 4★ total yet again on the UNDER (Top LPS Total now 26-6 (81% L3Y!) EC led 17-3 at the half, but benefitted from a blk'd punt td & were outFD'd 16-12. The Owls rebounded from their first loss with a 24-2 (-8) win over ex-FC Collins and Georgia Tech, giving them 2 wins over two P5 non-conference foes for the first time s/91! TU RB Davis ran for 135 (4.7), but the Owls did benefit from a 74 yd FR td & forced 3 TO's, all on their side of the field. The Pirates are a bit 1-dimensional on OFF as QB Ahlers is completing just 54% w/a 4-5 ratio & TU counters with our #23 ranked pass eff D, while holding foes to 115 ypg below their ssn avg. EC is 3-8 as a HD, on a 12-30 ATS run & is 1-22-1 ATS vs conference foes with a winning record, while TU is on a 38-18-1 ATS run & is 17-8-1 as road chalk.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 4TH

UCf at CINCINNATI - UCF is on a 3-0 SU/2-0 ATS series run, winning by 25 ppg & covering by 14 ppg! LY both were ranked & ESPN Gameday was on hand. Cincy was handed their most lopsided loss of the season, 38-13 (+7). This is the 'Cats lone home game in a 4 week stretch. The last time Cincy ply'd on a Friday was LY's home finale, a 56-6 (-19) win vs EC. UCF last played on a Friday in LY's regular season finale, travelling to USF & winning 38-10 (-14). Last week the 'Cats led Marshall 28-0 at HT & won 52-14 (-4) all'g just 128 yds the F3Q. UCF led UConn 42-0 at HT, rebounding from their 1st reg ssn loss s/16 with a 56-21 (-43) rout. The Knights have put up the most yds all'd by all 5 of their foes, but Cincy is holding their opponents to 113 ypg below their ssn avg. UCF is on a 25-12 ATS run & is 9-4 as road chalk, while Cincy is 1-5 as a HD.

New Mexico at SAN JOSE ST - SJSJ leads series 12-5-1, but have met just 4 times s/ '98 and the Spartans are 4-0 ATS in those games. NM is off a 17-10 loss at Liberty and has to travel back across the country on short rest, while SJSJ lost LW at Air Force 41-24. SJSJ put up 503 yds at Ark 2 wks ago and LW put up 378 on an AF DEF that came in all'g just 280 ypg. Spartans face an NM DEF that is #128 in the FBS, all'g 531 ypg and 42 ppg. NM's OFF can score (452 ypg, 30 ppg) and faces a SJSJ DEF all'g 513 ypg vs FBS foes, so expect points here. NM is on a 5-11 ATS slide in MW gms s/17 and in that same span is just 2-6 ATS in MW road gms. SJSJ is on a 7-4-1 ATS run at home vs MW foes s/16.

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SATURDAY OCTOBER 5TH

USF by 8 over UCONN - UConn is on a 3-0 ATS series run and the dog is 9-1. This is the Huskies lone home game in a 5 week stretch, but USF is travelling for just the 2nd time in the L/5 weeks & had a bye 2 weeks ago. Last year UConn lost 38-30 (+32) their first time in 6 gms vs FBS foes staying within 30 points! The Huskies squared off vs an angry UCF squad last week & trailed 56-0 late 3Q before gaining 201 of their 426 yds on 3 td drives. RFR QB Krajewski came off the bench to lead the td drives & HC Edsall indicated he would be the starter moving forward. The Bulls are still working out the kinks of their new OFF. RFR QB McCloud started LW vs SMU, but USF trailed 41-0 late 3Q & QB Barnett led 3 td drives that totaled 240 of their 342 tld yds despite being off a bye. UConn is 27-18 as a HD, while USF is 12-22 as road chalk & is on a 4-10 ATS run.

Boston College by 6 over LOUISVILLE - BC has won the last 2 meetings incl LTH when AJ Dillon had his coming out party with a 272 yd performance as the Eagles won as more than 3 td underdogs. The home team is 1-4 ATS in the series. We've used Boston College in B2B weeks as a LPS, picking up two straight 3★ winners on the Eagles. LW BC held 533-440 yd & 25-22 FD edges but were -2 TO's and lost to Wake Forest 27-24. Louisville enters fresh off a bye. QB Pass missed the Cardinals last gm vs Florida St and is a ? vs BC (CS). The strength of the Cardinals defense is their front 4 which is holding teams to 136 (3.6) rush ypg. AJ Dillon has topped 150 in 3 straight and BC is avg 251 (5.0) rush ypg. The Eagles defense ranks #117, allowing teams to put up 96 ypg more than their avg. Louisville is on a 1-8 ATS run vs ACC foes and is 2-6-1 ATS at home. BC has covered 8 of their last 10 road games.

Texas by 10 over WEST VIRGINIA - It's homecoming in Morgantown. WV is on a 3-1 series run & the host has covered 3 straight. TX is on an 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS run in road openers. Both schools enter off a bye after physical wins the week prior. The 'Horns are playing with revenge after allowing the GW td pass & 2 pt conversion by Will Grier (#3DC) with :16 left last year. TX is avg 498 ypg & is #9FBS avg 152 ypg more than their foes allow, but WV has held 3 of their F/4 opponents to their ssn low in yards. 'Horns dual threat QB Ehlinger is one of the premier signal callers in the nation, avg 4.5 ypc while completing 73% w/a 15-1 ratio. The best QB the Mountaineers have seen this year was Mizzou's Kelly Bryant & they all'd a 3-0 ratio. TX is 7-13 ATS in true road games, but WV is 5-12 ATS off a bye.

PENN ST by 20 over Purdue - It's homecoming in Happy Valley. PSt is on an 11-3 ATS series run, but the visitor has covered 6 of the L/7. LY NIU (-3) led 21-6 late 3Q but up just 21-16 needed 3 SOD of Ball St in NIU territory in 4Q. The Cardinals are off a bye, after losing 34-23 at NC State but covering as a 19.5 dog. They are led by QB Drew Plitt, who is avg 343 ypg (67.6%, 11-4). NIU is off a 24-18 loss at Vanderbilt (led by former Ball St QB Neal) getting the backdoor cover (+7) thanks to going for 2 with 11:44 left 4Q. Under 1st yr HC Hammock, this is not NIU offense that avg'd 225 ypg rush over the last 10 yrs as they are avg just 85 ypg (2.8 ypc). They are led by former Cal Starting QB Ross Bowers, who is avg 264 ypg pass (59.4%) but with just a 4-3 ratio. Ball St had the offensive edge (#65-#108) but NIU has the defensive edge (#75-#119) and we will look for the Huskies offense to exploit the Ball St defense (or lack of) here.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 9 over Ball St - Played for Bronze Stalk Trophy. NIU is 17-3 vs Ball St including 10 straight SU wins (covering the last 7). LY NIU (-3) led 21-6 late 3Q but up just 21-16 needed 3 SOD of Ball St in NIU territory in 4Q. The Cardinals are off a bye, after losing 34-23 at NC State but covering as a 19.5 dog. They are led by QB Drew Plitt, who is avg 343 ypg (67.6%, 11-4). NIU is off a 24-18 loss at Vanderbilt (led by former Ball St QB Neal) getting the backdoor cover (+7) thanks to going for 2 with 11:44 left 4Q. Under 1st yr HC Hammock, this is not NIU offense that avg'd 225 ypg rush over the last 10 yrs as they are avg just 85 ypg (2.8 ypc). They are led by former Cal Starting QB Ross Bowers, who is avg 264 ypg pass (59.4%) but with just a 4-3 ratio. Ball St had the offensive edge (#65-#108) but NIU has the defensive edge (#75-#119) and we will look for the Huskies offense to exploit the Ball St defense (or lack of) here.

Tulane by 3 over ARMY - It's homecoming in West Point. TU is on a 7-3 ATS run in the series & the visitor has covered 5 of the L/7 meetings (4-1 SU). The last matchup was in '17. Both schools enter off a bye. The Green Wave is travelling for the 1st time in 4 weeks. Expect a low scoring affair as both programs run the option. While Army runs the traditional triple-option, TU utilizes a spread-option. The Black Knights are all'g just 3.1 ypc, while the Green Wave have held 3 of their F/4 foes under 3.9 ypc, including Auburn. Army is just #118FBS on OFF, avg 71 ypg less than their foes allow.

Pittsburgh by 3 over DUKE - Pitt is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series. LY Pitt put up 484 rush yds but Duke didn't punt until the 4Q. The Panthers scored 9 pts in the L/05 and won 54-45. Duke enters off an impressive road win at Virg Tech, 45-10 (+2). QB Harris is completing 73% with a 10-2 ratio and is Duke's leading rusher as well (303, 5.9). Pitt was in a major flat spot last week vs New Hampshire (#19 FCS), coming off a win as a DD dog over UCF. They were missing more than a half dozen starters incl QB Pickett (inj, CS) yet outgained NH 443-170 but needed a 4Q td to win by a fg (-30). Pitt is +104 ypg and has outgained their L/4 foes by 141 ypg. Despite inj's the Panthers Dline has been a major strength, holding foes to 92 (2.9) rush ypg and they are #2 in the nation with 24 sacks! Pitt is holding teams 125 ypg below their avg (#9 in nation) and Duke is avg 39 ypg less than their opponents allow (#102 in nation). Narduzzi is 20-13 as a dog and 13-6 as an AD. Pitt owns this series and there has been 4 upsets in the L/5 mtgs. We will call for another.

Maryland by 9 over RUTGERS - MD is on a 3-1 SU/ATS series run, but the host has covered 3 straight. There has been 3 outright upsets in the L/5 meetings. LY the Terps all'd just 179 yds & won 34-7 (-24). RU hasn't won a B10 game since beating MD in '17. MD enters with an extra day of rest/prep following their embarrassing 59-0 (+6) home loss vs Penn St. The Terps were outg'd 619-128 & outFD'd 30-10. After starting the ssn completing 58% with a 7-1 ratio, Josh Jackson has completed 42% w/a 1-3 ratio his L/2 gms. RU is also off a shutout loss, 52-0 (+27) at Michigan that resulted in the firing of HC Ash on Sunday. The Knights were outg'd 476-152 & outFD'd 28-10. RU is being held to 101 ypg less than their foes allow on avg, but the Terps are all'g their opponents 52 ypg more than their avg. MD is on a 13-22 ATS run, but is 4-2 off a SU loss, while RU is on a 6-3 ATS run & is 6-2 ATS hosting B10 foes. There's no line at presstime.

Oklahoma St by 10 over TEXAS TECH - TT is on a 4-1 ATS run in the series, but the visitor has covered 7 of the L/9. This is the Red Raiders lone home game in a 5 week stretch, while OKSt is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks, but does have a bye on deck. The Pokes are ply'g with revenge after entering LY's contest ranked #15, but were blown out 41-17 (+14). That loss snapped OKSt's 9 gm series win streak and was the Red Raiders 1st win in Stillwater s/'01! That was the B12 debut for TT QB Bowman, but he was inj'd 3 weeks ago & remains out. Jackson Tyner started LW in the Red Raiders 55-16 (+27) blowout loss at Oklahoma, but was benched mid 1Q & Jeff Duttrey rep'd. The Pokes responded to their first loss with a 26-13 (-5) win over Kansas St. OKSt led by 10 before putting together a 6:11 scoring drive late 4Q. RB Hubbard entered as the FBS leading rusher & added 296 more yds! The Red Raiders have all'd their L/2 foes 258 (5.7) rush ypg. OKSt is on a 8-2 ATS run.

WISCONSIN by 42 over Kent St - First meeting. KSt enters fresh off a bye, but UW is home for the 5th straight week. The Badgers haven't hosted 2 MAC schools in the same season s/'92 & already blew out CM 61-0 (-35). The Golden Flashes have gone on the road twice vs P5 foes TY & lost by a comb'd score of 85-23. KSt has the Wagon Wheel rivalry on deck, but the Badgers are in a B10 sandwich. UW was held to just 243 yds & outFD'd 21-13 last week in their 24-15 (-24) win vs Northwestern, benefitting from 2 defensive tds. RB Taylor avg a ssn low 4.6 ypc, but will increase that this week against a KSt tm all'g 297 (5.1) rush ypg vs non-conference foes. KSt is 17-28 ATS vs non-conference foes including 4-9 vs the B10.

Eastern Michigan by 4 at CENTRAL MICHIGAN - 97th mtg. EM has just 30 series wins, but are 7-7 s/'04 but the visitor has lost 4 straight SU (2-2 ATS). This is part of the Michigan MAC Chmp (EM,CM & WM). LY despite CM (+13') playing a lot of young players (already eliminated from bowl bid), it was 7-7 at HT (CM 68 yg FR td) before EM scored 10 unanswered in 2H. CM is 4-1 ATS including the back door cover as a 16.5 pt AD LW, scoring a td (2 pt ng) w/3:26 left at WM. EM is off a bye. EM is 3-1 SU (2-2 ATS) including a 34-31 upset (+7') at Illinois, but the week after that win needed a miracle blocked punt td w/1:10 left to get by FCS foe Central Conn 34-29 (-32'). While that wake up call may help EM here these teams are very similar (EM #105-#110 Off, CM #98-#112 Def) and we will look for the Chippewas to keep it within the line.

MIAMI, FL by 8 over Virginia Tech - Miami is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series, the home team is 3-1 SU/ATS. Miami enters fresh off a bye following their lackluster 5 pt win vs C Mich. HC Fuente is feeling some heat after a 2-2 start with both wins being closer than expected vs lesser competition. The Hokies were blown out at home LW by Duke 45-10 (-2'), outgained 422-259. While neither team inspires much confidence, Miami is +51 ypg vs FBS foes and their defense is strong as expected, holding foes to 100 ypg below their avg (#28 in FBS). VT is -25 ypg vs FBS foes and QB Willis has been held under 125 pass yds in B2B games. The Hokies won't find much running room against a Canes D that allows 60 (2.1) rush ypg. Miami's struggling Oline got to use the bye week to fix their issues so we will call for the 'Canes to win by just under a td. VT is 8-4 as an AD. Miami is on a 3-8 ATS run vs FBS foes.

MISSOURI by 28 over Troy - Missouri is 11-1 SU all-time vs SBC foes but their only loss was vs Troy in '04. The Tigers have feasted on non Power-5 squads under HC Odom, going 8-3 ATS (avg win by 42 ppg). The Tigers covered 3 straight and are fresh off a bye. They've held their L3 foes to 179 ypg. Troy was 7 pt chalk LW vs banged up Ark St (missing QB & RB). The Trojans still allowed 558 yds and lost 50-43 despite being +2 TO's and +4 FD. Troy has given up 738 and 558 vs their 2 best opponents. Now they face a Missouri squad avg 68 ypg more than their opponents allow (#41 in nation). Kelly Bryant should have a field day against our #128 pass eff D. Troy is 10-4 as a dog but this is their first time in that role under new HC Lindsay and Odom's prowess for beating up on lesser opponents has us leaning with the favored Tigers.

NEW MEXICO ST by 1 over Liberty - For a second straight year these 2 Independents will play a home & home series in the same ssn. LY both HT's won SU, NMSt 49-41 (+3) & Liberty 28-21 (-7'). The Flames are off a 17-10 win over New Mexico with a 19-18 FD & 466-362 yd edge but failed to cover as a 7' pt HF. The Aggies played New Mexico the seek prior losing 55-52 on the road being outgained 598-489 but with 29-27 FD edge & covering as a 4.5 AD. The Aggies are off a 30-17 loss to Fresno St but covered as a 20' pt HD. As you would expect from the New Mexico comparison NMSt has the offensive edge (#103-#115), while Liberty has the defensive edge (#113-#127). While the Flames would seem to be the play here that is until you look at the mismatched strength of schedule edge for the Aggies (#11-#121). With Liberty being a road favorite here, we will take the points and look for NMSt to cover their 3rd straight vs Liberty.

Arizona by 4 over COLORADO - AZ is on a 6-1 SU/4-2 ATS series run & has covered 3 straight as the visitor. CU enters fresh off a bye & this is their lone home game in a 5 week span, but the 'Cats are travelling for the 1st time in 5 weeks and had a bye 2 weeks ago. LY AZ scored 26 pts in the 2Q and won 42-34 (-3), finishing w/a 566-383 yd edge. 'Cats QB Tate & RB Taylor were both surprise scratches & 6'6" true fresh QB Grant Gunnell, in his 1st career start, threw for 352 (66%) in LW's 20-17 (-6') win vs UCLA. This should be a high-scoring affair as the Buff's are avg 84 ypg more than their foes allow, while AZ is avg 83 ypg more than their opponents allow. AZ is on a 18-32-1 ATS run & is 1-5 ATS away off a SU win, but CU is 1-4 as a HD. There's no line at presstime.

UCLA by 7 over Oregon St - UCLA leads series 43-16-4 & is 9-3 SU the L/12 mtgs. Off a 32 point comeback 2 wks ago, UCLA missed a tying FG w/ 39 sec left LW at Ariz and lost 20-17 vs a bkp QB. UCLA QB Thompson-Robinson was inj'd late and is a ? to return (CS). Oreg St lost 31-28 on a Stanford GW FG w/ 1 sec left. Neither DEF is stout, as UCLA is all'g 514 ypg & 36 ppg while Oreg St is giving up 465 ypg & 38 ppg vs FBS foes. UCLA put up 67 pts on a better Wash St tm 2 wks ago and their OFF seems to be waking up (551 ypg the past 2 wks) while Oreg St put up 28 pts & 501 yds LW. Since '01 UCLA is 10-2 ATS against the Beavers & we'll back the Bruins here as Oreg St is 0-5 ATS in P-12 road openers the L5Y, losing by 32 ppg.

OREGON by 10 over California - UO is on a 9-1 SU/8-2 ATS series run & the host has covered 10 of the L/13. Cal enters with an extra day of rest/prep following their 24-17 (-4) loss vs AZSt last Friday & has a bye on deck, but UO is fresh off a bye. Not only did Cal's perfect ssn end last week, but QB Gabers, off the best game of his career at Ole Miss, was inj'd (shoulder, CS) in the 2Q and bkp Devon Modster was just 5-14-23-0-1. The Bears were outg'd 365-245. While the Ducks have 1 of the best QB's in the nation in Justin Herbert (74%, 14-0 ratio!), UO has held their L/3 foes to ssn lows in yds & is #15 FBS, holding opponents to 127 ypg below their avg! Cal is 7-0 as an AD including pulling off 2 outright upsets already this year, while UO is on a 13-27 ATS run. There's no line at presstime.

Washington by 6 over STANFORD - Dating back to 2003, Stanford is 10-5 SU/ATS against UW. The home team is also on a 6-2 ATS run going back to '11. UW is off a 28-14 home win vs USC while Stanford kicked a GW FG w/ 1 sec left to win 31-28 at Oreg St. Stanford is 14-9 ATS at home vs ranked foes s/'08 incl a 6-1 ATS mark as a HD taking on a ranked foe. UW is an impressive 7-2 ATS in P-12 road openers and we'll pick them to win outright. However, HC Shaw is 45-9 SU at home at Stanford & it is tough to go against Stanford's impressive mark as a HD vs ranked foes & the fact they have won 5 straight home gms SU vs UW by an avg of 18 pts.

Iowa by 1 over MICHIGAN - It's homecoming in Ann Arbor. UM is on a 1-5 SU run in the series, but has covered 5 of the L/8. The host is on a 3-1 ATS run & there has been 2 outright upsets in the L/4 meetings. The last matchup was in '16 & the last time the Wolves hosted IO was in '12. UM has been home 5 of the L/6 weeks, but the Hawkeyes are travelling outside of Iowa for the 1st time. The Wolves have won 27 of their L/35 B10 home games, including 6 in a row SU. New UM OC Gattis was moved from the press box to the field for the first time LW & the 'Wolves responded from their embarrassing effort at Wisconsin 2 wks ago with their best game by shutting out Rutgers 52-0 (-27'). It was their 1st shutout s/'16 (also vs RU). IO is 4-0 SU for the 3rd time in 10Y after blowing out MT 48-3 (-23'), cashing our 4th straight Early Bird winner (available for FREE every Monday on Button 9!) Their 644 tll yds was the most ever under 21Y HC Ferentz! The Hawkeyes are #11FBS, holding foes to 134 ypg less than their avg. IO is 25-11-2 ATS away from Iowa City, while UM is on a 1-7 ATS run.

MINNESOTA by 10 over Illinois - It's homecoming in Minneapolis. MN is on a 12-5 SU/ATS series run including 6-2 ATS as the host. The Gophers had won 3 straight meetings, but are ply'g with revenge after all'g a ssn high 430 rush yds resulting in the firing of their DC after Ly's 55-31 (-9') loss. IL has lost 14 of their L/17 gms SU following a reg ssn bye. MN enters 4-0 SU after their 38-31 (-1') win at Purdue. The Gophers led 38-17 mid 4Q as QB Morgan set car highs with 396 pass yds & 4 TD's. The Illini have our #86 ranked pass eff D, all'g 61% completions & a 6-3 ratio. MN is 6-13 as home chalk.

NEBRASKA by 10 over Northwestern - It's homecoming in Lincoln. NU is on a 1-3 ATS series run and the visitor has covered 6 straight. The 'Huskies are on the 2nd of B2B home games, while NW is on the 2nd of B2B away games, but does have a bye on deck. The L/8 meetings have been decided by a total of 51 points (6 ppg). LY NU led by 10 w/5:51 left, but all the game tying td w/12 remaining & lost 34-31 (+3') in OT. The 'Huskies enter off a humbling 48-7 (+17) loss vs Ohio State. NU was held under 100 tll yds until late 3Q. NW meanwhile, cont'd its trend of slow starts early in the ssn, only to improve each week as they only lost at Wisconsin 24-15 (+24). The 'Cats had a 21-13 FD edge, but all'd fumble & IR td's. QB Johnson has been banged up off & on and was inj'd again LW (CS). NU is on a 9-3 ATS run. Despite the trends, we feel NU will right the early season issues this week and win by DD's.

Georgia by 28 over TENNESSEE - UGA has won the last 2 meetings by 41 & 26 points. Both teams enter fresh off a bye. UGA used their bye to recover from a physical win over Notre Dame where they held the Irish to a ssn low 321 yds (131 yds below their avg). Tenn had numerous issues to address during their bye after getting smoked by injury plagued Florida. HC Pruitt split the QB reps during the bye and while Guarantano will likely start, True frosh Maurer could see action. The Vols avg 62 ypg less than their opponents allow (#110 in nation) and they've yet to settle on an Oline, rotating as many as 10 guys at times. Tenn's pass D could keep them in the game (#26 in pass eff D) but the Vols will have a hard time scoring against the Dawgs defense that has held all 4 foes to their ssn low yds (-195 ypg below foes avg). HC Smart is 8-4 as an AF and is on a 16-6 ATS run vs SEC foes. The Vols have lost their L/5 vs FBS foes by 20 ppg and none of those teams were at UGA's level.

NAVY by 3 over Air Force - These arch rivals have alternated wins & losses each of the L6Y, while AF is on a 4-1 ATS run. The host is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS & there has been 2 outright upsets the L5Y. Navy is ply'g with revenge after finishing with a ssn low 9 FD's & losing 35-3 (-3) LY, their lowest scoring output in the rivalry s/'10. This is the Midlands lone home game in a 4 week span, while the Falcons are travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks. Both enter off weekday games last week, with Navy off a 35-23 (+10') loss at Memphis in a gm they had 20-12 FD & 373-301 yd edges. The Midlands all'd a 99 yd KOR td & QB Perry was forced to leave the field 3 times (CS), but was at the post game presser. AF beat SJSU 41-24 (-19') last Friday in a gm that inj'd st'g QB Hammond was needed after bkp Sanders was inj'd on the initial drive. The Falcons finished w/a 513-378 yd edge. AF is 11-4 as an AD, but Navy is 12-6 as home chalk & is on a 5-1 ATS run in the regular ssn. There's no line at presstime.

BU has won a B12 best 6 straight games after their emotional 23-21 (+3) victory vs Iowa St. The Bears led 20-0 4Q before all'g 21 unanswered to trail for the first time TY, but kicked the GW 38 yd fg w/:21 left (2nd outright winner L3W on Button 3 Underdog POW, available FREE every Tuesday!) QB Brewer is completing 66% w/a 10-0 ratio, but KSst has our #13 pass eff D, all'g just 51% w/a 2-5 ratio. KSst is 4-9 as home chalk. HC Ruhle has done a great job with Baylor, getting them to a bowl LY & able to handle diversity this year. We'll call for the outright upset, making this our Underdog Play of the Week!!

TOLEDO by 1 over Western Michigan - This is a HUGE matchup in the MAC West race as they are expected to be the top 2 in the division & head-to-head is the first tie-breaker. Toledo is on a 7-2 SU series run including winning & covering the L/2 by an avg 18 ppg. LY both teams lost their starting QB in 1H but the Rockets never trailed & led 44-17 with 9:25 left 3Q, winning 51-24 as a 6' pt AD. WM is just 1-3 SU in the Glass Bowl s/'11. The Broncos led rival CM 24-0 in 3Q LW winning 31-15 but just failed to cover as a 16' pt HF. The Rockets have won 3 straight gms (2-1 ATS) but LW as a 2' pt HD trailed BYU 14-3 early 4Q. They scored 14 unanswered in the 4Q including the GW td w/:51 that was set up by a 40 yd IR to the BYU2. While UT has history & the home field edge, WM has the edges on both sides (Off #27-#54, Def #96-#11) and should keep it very close.

Oklahoma by 24 over KANSAS - OU is on a 9-4 ATS series run & the visitor has covered 3 of the L/4 meetings. LY KU RB Williams ran for a career high 252 yards in the 55-40 (+34') loss, their highest scoring total to their prior 5 meetings combined. KU has a bye on deck. The 'Hawks enter off their 46th straight B12 road loss, this time a 51-14 (+14') setback at TCU. KU was held to 55 yds thru 3Q's! The Sooners are off a blowout 55-16 (-27) win over Texas Tech. QB Hurts threw for a car high 415 yds and is trending towards OU's third consecutive Heisman winner! The Sooners are #1 FBS on OFF, avg 231 ypg more than their foes allow! KU is all'g 256 (4.7) rush ypg in B12 play & is #89 in our pass eff D rankings. KU covered their only other game this season as a 20+ dog & we feel will do so again this week.

BUFFALO by 3 over Ohio - The HT is 11-2 in this series incl 9 str wins & 6 straight covers. LY in the 2nd last gm of reg ssn, UB needed to win just 1 of their L/2 to win the MAC East, while Ohio needed to win to stay in race. UB led 7-0, but Ohio led 31-10 at HT & 45-10 into 4Q easily covering 52-17 as a 2' pt HF. LTH Ohio never led but tied the gm at 24 w/:53 3Q but lost 31-24 (-6') being int'd in EZ w/1:20 left. The Bobcats are a disappointing 1-3 SU & ATS with their only win over an FCS foe. The Bulls are 2-3 SU & 1-4 ATS but along with win over an FCS foe also beat Temple 38-22 as a 14 pt HD & led Penn St 10-7 at HT, finishing with surprising 22-14 FD & 429-357 yd edge (-1 TO, PSU IR td). The Bulls dropped their MAC opener LW 34-20 as a 2' pt AF at Miami. They actually had a 20-16 FD & 398-265 yd edge (incl 309 rush) but had a 0-4 TO ratio. After losing 45-25 to Louisiana as a 3 pt HF, Ohio had a bye LW which may help them work on their run defense that is allowing 209 ypg (5.5 ypc). The Bulls have been leaning on their running game TY avg 240 ypg rush (4.7 ypc) but will need to hang onto the ball to pull the upset here.

IOWA ST by 7 over Tcu - TCU has won 7 of the L/9 in the series, but ISt has covered 3 in a row. The home team has won 4 of the L/5 including 3 straight, but the visitor has covered 3 of the L/4. This is the lone home game in a 4 week stretch for the 'Clones, but TCU has a bye on deck. This is the first time in 10 meetings that TCU is the dog. LY the Frogs all'd just 198 total yards and won 17-14 (-10'), kicking the GW 28 yard fg w/:37 left. ISt enters off an emotional 23-21 (-3) loss at Baylor, their 4th straight B12 opening loss under HC Campbell. The 'Clones trailed 20-0 in the 4Q, but rallied to take a 1 point lead before all'g the GW 38 yd fg w/:21 left. With RB Montgomery in the NFL, ISt has been leaning on QB Purdy, who is completing 69% w/a 8-2 ratio. The Frogs enter off a 51-14 (-14') blowout over Kansas, all'g under 100 td yds thru 3Q's. True frosh QB Duggan continues to look more comfortable leading the controls & has a perfect 7-0 ratio. ISt is on a 24-12 ATS run, while TCU is on a 16-24 ATS run.

OLE MISS by 6 over Vanderbilt - The home team is 4-0 SU and has covered 3 straight. The 'Dores are 8-2 ATS in Oxford. Last week Vandy jumped out to a 14-0 lead over N Illinois. They led 24-10 4Q when NIU scored and inexplicably added a 2 pt conv, wrecking our top LPS in the process. RB Vaughn was the first to top 100 rush yds vs the Huskies in the last 17 games. Ole Miss was w/o QB Corral last week at Bama (inj, CS). True Frosh Plumlee got his first career start and while he only completed 36%, he did rush for 109 (4.4). UM actually led 10-7 1Q but trailed 45-10 3Q. UM's final td came with just :05 left. Vandy is allowing 502 ypg, and they give up 53 ypg more than their foes allow (#102 in nation). Ole Miss avg 423 ypg and 94 ypg more than their foes allow (#23 in nation). The Rebels have held their opp's to 107 (3.3) rush but must contend with RB Vaughn who has topped 100 in B2B games. Vandy is 3-11 as an SEC dog but Ole Miss is just 6-10 ATS at home and 2-8 ATS vs SEC foes.

Marshall by 1 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - Marshall is out for revenge for LY's 10 pt home loss. The visitor has won the L/2. We went against the Herd on these pages LW and picked up an easy 2★ winner with Cincinnati(-4) jumping out to a 45-0 lead before Marshall added 2 garbage time td's. We also went against MT, picking up our 4th straight Early Bird Winner (free on Mondays, Button 9 Comp, call 1-800-654-3448) as Iowa destroyed the Blue Raiders 48-3 (-23'). MT was outgained by 428 yds and the 644 yds allow was their most given up since 2014. MT is -235 ypg vs 3 P5 foes. Marshall is -154 ypg vs 3 FBS foes but none were P5. QB O'Hara has been solid replacing a 4Y starter (70%, 8-2 ratio, 235 rush, 4.5) and we expect the Blue Raiders to show improvement in a big step down in competition. Marshall is on a 7-17-1 ATS run as chalk and HC Holliday is just 10-17-2 as an AF. Marshall gets their revenge, but not by much.

NOTRE DAME by 50 over Bowling Green - First meeting despite campuses being just 165 miles apart. While this looks to be a flat spot for Notre Dame which is 7-0 vs current MAC teams, Coach Kelly will remind them that LY #8 Notre Dame only got past MAC foe Ball St 24-16 as a 34' pt HF. The Falcons are off a bye but after winning their opener over an FCS team the Falcons are 0-3 SU & ATS including a 52-0 pt loss to Kansas St, allowing 521 yds & a 42 pt loss to Kent St as allowing 750!!! yds (375 ru/375 pass). With their loss Georgia 2 wks ago and after trailing Virginia 17-14 at HT LW, look for a focused Irish team to put this game well out of reach in the first half and the backups still have the edge over a rebuilding BG team that is allowing FBS foes 575 ypg.

Arkansas St by 12 over GEORGIA ST - Ark St leads series 5-0 SU & the home team is just 1-4 ATS. Ark St is avg'g 43 pts & 453 yds vs GSt while all'g the Panthers to gain 389 ypg & 26 ppg. Ark St lost starting QB Bonner for the ssn, but LW vs Troy RS frosh QB Hatcher threw for 440 yds & 4 td in an upset win at Troy. GSt is off a bye, but prior to that lost in 3 OT at TXSt. Ark St's pass attack did not skip a beat LW and are avg'g 317 ypg and face a GSt pass D ranked #123. GSt will have a shot to get their OFF back on track here as Ark St is all'g 500 ypg this ssn & this could be a high scoring gm. Ark St HC Anderson is 12-5 ATS in SBC road gms s/'15 while GSt is just 3-8-1 ATS in their new stadium & we'll back the Red Wolves to get another SBC road win.

Wku by 3 over OLD DOMINION - WKU is 4-1 SU but ODU won LY and they've covered 2 straight. The 'Toppers only put up 222 yds LW but pulled an upset over UAB (+3) thanks to 4 interceptions. ODU continues to struggle on offense, which is why we used Under 46' as our top Totals Play LW, picking up yet another winner (Top Late Phone Total is now 26-6, 81% L3Y, Totals 13-6, 68% on the ssn). ODU avg just 295 ypg and QB Smartt continues to struggle (63%, 1-4 ratio) while his Oline hasn't helped much (16 sks allowed). WKU HC Helton has already pulled 2 CUSA upsets, incl at FIU. WKU has held opp's to 109 ypg below their avg (#24 in FBS) and they could pick up a few more int's against TO prone QB Smartt. WKU is on an 0-5 run as an AF.

FIU by 29 over UMass - This series is tied 2-2, home team is 4-0 SU/ATS. FIU won L/2 scoring 63 pts in both and they host for the third straight year. The Panthers enter fresh off a bye. UMass proved they aren't the worst team in FBS by beating Akron 37-29 (+7'). QB Curtis got his first career start and threw for 173 and 2 td's. FIU has been a massive disappointment, losing all 3 games vs FBS foes. QB Morgan returned from inj prior to the bye and had his best game vs LA Tech, throwing for 394. Now he faces our #130 pass eff D that allows 74% and 289 pass ypg plus 236 (5.9) rush ypg. The UMass D allows 206 ypg more than their foes avg. FIU is just 3-7 as a HF but they are experienced and better than their 1-3 record indicates. UMass is 1-6 as an AD and entered '19 as our #130 most experienced team and they've performed like it.

Memphis by 15 over ULM - Both schools are in conference sandwiches. Memphis had a bye 2 wks ago, is travelling for just the 2nd time in 6 weeks, and enters off a couple extra days of rest/prep following their 35-23 (-10') win vs Navy last Thursday. The Tigers were out'd 373-301 & out'FD'd 20-12 and benefitted from a 99 yd KOR td. ULM is on the 2nd of B2B home games. Both have played South Alabama, with the Tigers winning by 36 pts and finishing with a 530-248 yard edge, while the Warhawks won by 13 pts with a 428-377 yd edge. ULM is #126 FBS on D, all'g 151 ypg more than their foes avg & UM's offense, led by QB Brady White, is avg 443 ypg & offers a balanced attack. UM is 16-9 ATS vs non-conference foes, is on a 15-4 ATS run in the regular ssn & is 6-2 as road chalk, while ULM is 3-8 as a HD & is on a 7-14 ATS run.

OHIO ST by 12 over Michigan St - It's homecoming in Columbus. OSt has won the L2Y by a comb'd score of 74-9, but the visitor is on a 7-1 SU/8-2 ATS run. The Buckeyes have a bye on deck. OSt is looking more complete each and every week and enters off a blowout 48-7 (-17) win at Nebraska. The Buckeyes finished w/31-15 FD & 580-231 yd edges and scored on their F/6 possessions. MSt enters off a physical 40-31 (-14) win over Indiana. Sparty kicked the GW 21 yd fg w/:05 left and added a late td via the Hoosiers unsuccessful lateral attempt on the games final play. MSt did finish w/a 442-356 yd edge, but they did allow Indiana QB Penix to complete 79% with 3 td passes. The Buckeyes look like the most complete team in the nation. They've put up the most yds all'd by their L/4 foes & have held all 5 opponents to season lows in yards. MSt is 8-3 as an AD. Sparty typically does well in Columbus & we expect another closer than expected finish.

LSU by 21 over Utah St - These two haven't met since '01. LSU enters fresh off a bye. The Tigers offense has been on a roll, avg 564 ypg and QB Burrow is putting up video game numbers (81%, 17-2 ratio). Utah St counters with an experienced QB in Jordan Love and they avg 533 ypg and have even faced a slightly tougher sked. The Aggies enter off a 10 pt win over Colorado St and UTSt led +148 yd & +14 FD edges. Utah St avg 128 ypg more than their opponents allow (#15 in FBS). There is no doubt that LSU's offense is potent (they've put up the most yards all 4 opponents have allowed) but their defense could be missing quite a few starters and they've got Florida on deck. We wouldn't be surprised if Utah St hung around and got some late td's.

UTEP by 1 over Utsa - UTSA has won the last 2 meetings. Neither team has beaten an FBS foe this year. UTEP enters off a 31-13 (+26') loss at Southern Miss. UTSA is fresh off a bye after being crushed at North Texas 45-3. The RoadRunners are -76 ypg and have been held under 300 yds in 17 of their last 20 fbs FBS foes. LY UTEP actually held the yards edge but lost by 9 pts. There's not much good to say about either team but UTEP does seem to be improving while UTSA is going the wrong way so we will take the Miners by 1 point to pull the upset.
Boise St by 23 over UNLV - Boise is 4-0 SU (1-3 ATS) vs UNLV as MW foes, but their avg MOV was 24 pts in those 4 wins. Boise's lone ATS win as MW foes was LTH ('15) when the Broncos (-20') won 55-27. Boise enters off a bye while UNLV lost their top RB Williams (2nd in MW w/472 rush yds) & QB Rogers before HT at WY & lost 53-17. Status on both players is unknown as of presstime & not having them would hamper UNLV even more vs a Boise D that is holding foes to 299 ypg & 17 ppg. UNLV is all'g 479 ypg incl 288 rush ypg & are facing a Boise OFF that is avg'g 476 yds. Boise HC Harsin is 18-8 ATS as an AF here incl a 5-0 ATS mark the L3Y as 20+ pt favorites while UNLV is 3-6 ATS under HC Sanchez as a HD & Boise should roll by more than 3 TD's.

4★ HOUSTON over Atlanta - The Falcons woes against the AFC continued a week ago against TEN as they were held to just 10 pts in the 14 pt home defeat (3★ LP Winner on the Titans, ATL now on an 0-12 non-conf ATS run!). ATL is now facing the AFC South for the 3rd consec week as they head to HOU to take on a Texans squad who was held to just 10 pts & 264 yds in a home loss to CAR. With the Falcons having failed to cover 12 of their past 15 overall coming in and the Texans going 12-6 ATS as home chalk, the smart money will be HOU to bounce back in this one.

FORECAST: HOUSTON by 13

3★ CAROLINA over Jacksonville - The Jaguars and Panthers will forever be connected in NFL history as they each established their franchises back in the 1995 season. Since that point, they have combined for a 16-15 playoff record with the Panthers falling in the Big Game on 2 separate occasions (3-3 in all-time meetings). The Panthers are now 2-0 with bkp QB Allen under center following a 16-10 LW at HOU (297-264 yd edge) while the Jaguars earned their 2nd largest comeback road win in franchise history (trailed by 14) against the Broncos behind 225 rush yds from Fournette. While both of these squads have favorable comparisons in their respective histories, the trend that stands out to us the most in this matchup is JAX's inability to get the job done against non-conf foes as they've now failed to cover 20 of the past 24 meetings against the NFC dating back to 2013.

FORECAST: CAROLINA by 10

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Denver (+) over LA CHARGERS - After yet another hard fought loss a week ago at home against the Jaguars where they were gashed for 269 yds on the ground (JAX GW 33 yd FG as time expired), the Broncos remain winless on the season. They now head to Los Angeles to take on a Chargers team that had no issue moving to 2-2 on the season LW in South Beach against the Dolphins with a 30-10 victory (22-12 FD & 390-235 yd edges). In their Wk 11 trip here a year ago, the Broncos (+7) erased a 19-7 deficit in the 3Q of the eventual 23-22 upset win (34-yd FG on final play, LAC 26-16 FD & 479-325 yd edges). While we'll go ahead and call for the Chargers to get the outright victory this time around, leaning too much in their direction is a bit risky as they've failed to cover 7 of their past 9 as a HF including an 0-2 ATS mark so far this season.

FORECAST: LA CHARGERS by 1

OTHER PLAYS

LA Rams at SEATTLE - Thursday - Pivotal early season matchup inside of the NFC West between the Rams and Seahawks. Following a surprising 15 pt home loss against the Bucs that saw TB put up 55 on the scoreboard with 464 ttl yds, the Rams head to the Pacific NW where they've come out victorious in each of the past 2 years (42-7 & 33-31 wins). The Seahawks meanwhile got back into the win column LW in the desert against the Cardinals behind another solid day from QB Wilson (22-28-240-1-0). Although the Rams have covered 7 of their past 11 inside of the DIV, it's worth mentioning that 3 of those 4 spread defeats came at the hands of SEA. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

Baltimore by 3 over PITTSBURGH - The Steelers are back in Heinz Field for a 2nd consec week albeit on short rest following a DIV contest against the Bengals on MNF. While the Ravens are also off of an AFC North meeting (15 pt loss at home vs CLE, outgained 530-394), they come in as the favorite this time around in PIT with Big Ben on the shelf for the remainder of the year. In their 2 matchups of a season ago, the road team came out victorious in each (BAL 26-14 win in Wk 4 as a 3 pt AD). Although it wouldn't surprise us to see the Ravens claim the outright win once again here, PIT's 11-4-1 ATS run as a HD and recent overall success in this series (won 4 of the past 5 SU) has us leaning in their direction.

Chicago by 10 over Oakland - London. After a 7 pt win against the banged-up Colts a week ago where they had a 377-346 yd edge, the road weary Raiders head across the pond for the 2nd consec year (3rd time in franchise history, 0-2 SU & ATS w/a 24 pt avg margin of defeat). The Bears (24-18 win over TB in London back in '11) recent schedule hasn't been much better over recent weeks as this marks their 3rd road trip in 4 wks with LW's 10 pt win over MIN the only matchup coming inside of Soldier Field. With the Raiders (3-12-2 ATS vs NFC, 1-6-1 ATS before a bye) and the Bears (6-2-1 ATS vs AFC, 4-0 ATS before a bye) the polar opposite as far as trends are concerned in this one, it's quite obvious which way we're going here despite CHI QB Trubisky likely missing this matchup.

CINCINNATI by 6 over Arizona - Following a 17 pt DIV home loss to the Seahawks, the Cardinals head to CIN sporting a rough 2-8-1 ATS mark as a NDIV AD. The Bengals have also failed to taste victory so far in '19 as of presstime and return to action on short rest after their MNF meeting with PIT (only HG for CIN in a 4-wk stretch). Although both teams appear to be on the way to the basement in their respective divisions, we're leaning with the Bengals in this one as they're on a 6-1 ATS run overall while ARZ has failed to cover 9 of their past 13.

Minnesota by 7 over NY GIANTS - The Giants fanbase is starting to get excited following their 2nd consec victory since Daniel Jones took over under center as we easily cashed our 4★ Sept GOM in dominating fashion (NYG 23-8 FD & 389-176 yd edges). The rookie QB now faces the toughest test of his young career this week against the Vikings who struggled LW in the "Windy City" against the Bears (held to 6 pts & 223 yds). In the 2 most recent matchups in this series ('15 & '16), the Giants fell by a 73-27 score despite being outgained by just 32 combined yards. With NY having failed to cover 6 of their past 7 as a HD and MIN finding success in their recent role as an AF (7-3 ATS mark), we'll call for Jones to earn his 1st loss as a starter in this one.

New England by 17 over WASHINGTON - After covering 9 of their LW/10 as a NDIV AF heading into '18, the Patriots dropped 4 of 5 in that role a year ago (4 outright upsets). NE's defense has been virtually unstoppable so far in '19 however following their 6 pt win over previously unbeaten BUF (Patriots D has all'd just 1 TD dating back to LY's Super Bowl!). The Redskins meanwhile are still in search of their 1st victory as LW's 21 pt loss to the Giants (4★ GOM Winner on NYG!) is their 6th consec defeat dating back to the end of LY. While WAS has covered 9 of their past 13 against the AFC and are getting more than a TD inside of their home venue, there's absolutely no way that we're going against the Patriots (8-4 ATS vs NFC) at this time!

PHILADELPHIA by 10 over NY Jets - Following a 7 pt win last Thur in Lambeau to get back to 2-2 on the year (GB 491-336 yd edge), the Eagles find themselves in non-conf action for the 1st time TY (14-6-1 ATS vs AFC). NEW ORLEANS by 3 over Tampa Bay - Following a 2 pt home win against undefeated DAL that saw them surrender just 10 pts & 257 yds, the Saints are back in the "Big Easy" once again to take on a TB squad who delivered the biggest shocker of Wk 4 with a 15 pt road win at the Rams (QB Winston 385 yds & 4 TD's). While offense is expected to be at a premium once again, a head injury to QB Allen for the Bills (? at presstime) has us backing the home squad in this one.

DALLAS by 3 over Green Bay - Following a surprising 2 pt loss LW in the Superdome to the Brees-less Saints where their offense was held to 224 yds under their ssn avg, the Cowboys return home to take on their 2nd straight tough opponent after easily skating past the Giants, Redskins & Dolphins to begin 2019.
