4★ Florida over VANDERBILT - Florida hasn't lost at Vanderbilt since 1988, having won 13 straight and they are 7-3 ATS in Nashville. This game was tied at halftime last year but Florida outgained Vandy 467-310 and won by 2 td's (-9). We called for Florida to upset LSU as a 3★ Key Selection last week and the Gators did exactly that, winning 27-19 (+2'). Vandy allowed Georgia to put up a ssn high 560 yards in their 41-13 (+25') loss at UGA. Florida's D continues to improve since their loss to KY, holding foes to 287 ypg in their L4. QB Franks should have solid success vs Vandy's #84 pass eff D and the 'Dores may be w/o their top LB Charles Wright again. Vandy is 1-9 ATS vs SEC foes incl 0-4 as a home dog.

3★ CALIFORNIA over Ucla - Following a closer than expected loss LW at home against the Huskies where QB Thompson-Robinson nearly surpassed the 300 yd passing mark (272 yds, 2-1 ratio), the Bruins head North winless on the season having been outscored by 18 ppg. Despite huge FD (25-13) and yardage (476-265) edges, the Bears were unable to recover from 4 TO's in LW's loss in Tucson. In LY's meeting in Pasadena where the Bruins were without star QB Rosen in the 2H, UCLA would hold on late to earn bowl eligibility at 6-6. With the home team in this series on a 16-2 SU run (14-3-1 ATS) and Cal seeing their bowl hopes end in that season finale loss of a year ago, it's clear which direction we'll be leaning in this one.

3★ Duke (+) over GEORGIA TECH - Duke has covered the L/4 in this series, winning 3 of the L/4 SU, all outright upsets. Georgia Tech was in a great situation last week, facing Louisville, who had never seen GT's option and was on short rest. The Jackets had their most rush yds since 2011 with 542 (8.3) in their 66-31 (-5) road win. This week Duke has the situational edge despite being on the road. The Blue Devils have covered 6 of their L/7 when coming off a bye and HC Cutcliffe is known for shutting the option down, having covered 8 of their L/9 vs option tms. Duke's D is led by AA LB Joe-Giles Harris and in their opener, they held Army's option to 168 rush yds (3.6) which is 140 yds below their avg. The bye also gave Duke QB Jones a chance to further heal from the inj that sidelined him for 2 gms. The Jackets have allowed 350 pass ypg in their L/2 and are #86 in our pass eff D ratings. We will call for Duke to win by over a td.

2★ Ucf over MEMPHIS - UM has covered each of the L/3 home meetings, but lost both road meetings SU LY including the AAC Title game. UCF enters on a nation best 18 gm winning streak following their 28 pt win vs SMU. They're avg 100 ypg more than their foes allow & has finished w/the most yds all'd by each of their L/2 foes. Following their unexpected flat performance in the loss at Tulane, UM enters off an expected blowout over UConn where RB's Darrell Henderson & Patrick Taylor comb'd for 335 (13.4) rush yds! UM is home for the 4th time in 5 weeks, but their D is banged up & while UConn's didn't have the offense to take advantage, UCF & their Heisman hopeful QB McKenzie Milton certainly does. UCF is 6-2 as an AF. FORECAST: Ucf by 8

2★ Michigan St (+) over PENN ST - It's homecoming in Happy Valley. MSU is on a 4-1 ATS series run. PSU is in revenge mode after losing outright despite being nearly double-digit chalk LY. PSU enters fresh off a bye following their emotional loss vs OSU. MSU enters angry following their upset home loss vs NW. Trailing by 3 MSU was SOD at their own 11 & all'd a short td drive for a misleading final. Sparty was +44 yds. RB LJ Scott has missed the L/3 gms (CS). PSU is avg 129 ypg more than their foes allow, while holding those same foes to 115 ypg less than their avg. MSU is all'g 34 (1.3) rush ypg! MSU is 7-3 as an AD & will force PSU to be one dimensional.

Texas Tech vs TCU - The Saddle Trophy is on the line for these B12 rivals. TT is on a 4-2 ATS series run. Both schools enter fresh off a bye. TT QB Alan Bowman suffered a collapsed lung vs WV & it's unknown if game 1 starter McLane Carter is healed from his high ankle sprain. If not Jeff Duffey will see the field & while he's a running threat, he's also TO prone. TCU QB Shawn Robinson is reminding fans of Andy Dalton with similar stats early in his career, but an inj'd shoulder suffered at the end of their last game has his status a ? here (CS). Soph Michael Collins will make his 1st career start if Robinson is out. TT has an improved defense, while their high potent offense has finished w/the most yards allowed by their L/3 foes. TT is 10-4 as an AD, while TCU is 2-8 as a HF. Georgia Southern vs TEXAS STATE - GS has won both prior meetings as Sun Belts foes, but this is their first meeting since the 2015 ssn. GS is 4-1 SU this ssn and are off to their best start since '15 ssn when they started 5-1 SU. The Eagles rushing attack is strong this year, gaining 275 rush ypg on the ground. TXSt on the other hand has trouble stopping the run & just gave up 308 rush yds to Louisiana last week. GS is 10-6 SU in SBC road gms with their avg win by 18 ppg. TXSt is 2-12 SU at home under HC Withers while the Eagles are on a 7-1 ATS.

Usf by 9 over TULSA - This is TU's 3rd straight weekday game. TU enters on 1 extra days rest following their misleading 15 point loss at Hou last Thurs. TU led by 9 early 4Q and was only outg'd 477-426, but TO's led to 17 points all'd in 91 seconds. RFr Seth Boomer replaced Luke Skipper, but in his 1st car start compl just 42% vs a below avg pass D. RB Shamari Brooks DNP (CS) & bkp Corey Taylor inj'd his ankle late (CS). USF led at UMass just 20-14 at the half, but was up 58-35 & all'd a gbg td w/:15 left. However they were outFD'd by a double-digit margin for the 2nd straight gm. RB Cronkrite entered the gm w/304 yds & had 302 (13.1)! TU is all'g 240 (5.5) rush ypg vs FBS foes. This is TU's lone HG in a 5 wk stretch.

UTAH by 14 over Arizona - Following their 19 pt road upset of the Cardinal LW where they forced 4 TO's (outgained 423-421), the Utes are back in SLC for the first time in nearly a month. The Wildcats meanwhile moved to 3-3 on the year after also taking advantage of 4 TO's in a game that they were outFD'd (25-13) and outgained (476-265) by significant margins. Despite a 448-341 yd deficit in LY's trip to Tucson, Utah was able to force 5 TO's in the eventual 30-24 (-3') victory. While there's been 6 outright upsets in this series and the Wildcats are on a 7-4 ATS run, their 2-10 ATS mark as an AD has us giving the small lean with the Utes in this one.

SAN DIEGO ST by 12 over Air Force - SDSt has won 7 in a row SU in this series and is 7-1 ATS the last 8 meetings. SDSt is off of a big road win at Boise St despite their leading rusher Juwan Washington missing the gm. Donald Hammond was the starter for AF after he nearly led a comeback vs Nevada the week prior. AF is 5-2-1 as a MW underdog since/2015 and is 5-1 as a home dog since 2014. SDSt HC Long defends the option well. AF QB Hammond has taken over the ofense for the Falcons. SDSt was 6-2 ATS in MW play a ssn ago and despite losing some key players to inj, just keep finding ways to win under HC Rocky Long. We cannot ignore the fact SDSt has won 7 straight in this series and we like the Aztecs to pick up their 8th straight win over AF in this one.

The Eagles could be without Dillon this week (CS) after he missed last week's 28-23 (+6') at NCSt. BC was outgained 303-105 in the 1H (19-4 FD deficitt) and trailed 28-3 3Q. Louisville was handed their worst home loss in Cardinal Stadium's 20Y history in their 66-31 (+5) home loss. UL put up 483 yds but 210 of their yds came in the 4Q after falling behind 52-17. QB Pass continues to struggle, compl 55% with a 6-7 ratio and now he has to deal with a BC pass D that is #15 in our pass eff D ratings. L'ville has faced a much tougher sked (#45 vs #130) but BC is 10-1 as a fav vs ACC foes. We've gone against Louisville all year and will continue to do so.

Miami, Fla by 8 over VIRGINIA - Last year Miami was off two huge wins as home dogs, beating VT and ND and were ranked #3 at home vs UVA. The Cavaliers led 28-14 at half but UM forced 4 TO's and held UVA to 99 2H yds and won 44-28 (-19'). The 'Canes could once again be in a flat spot after rallying from a 27-7 deficit to beat rival Florida St. QB Perry had an uneven performance, throwing 4 td passes, but only compl'g 41%. UVA is fresh off a bye. Their D is #25, allowing 88 ypg less than their opponent's avg and they rank #22 in our pass eff D rankings. QB Perkins has been solid, compl'g 63% (11-4 ratio, 337 rush) but he's facing his toughest test vs UM's D that is #3, holding opponent's to 155 ypg less than their avg and they are #13 in our pass eff D. UM's DL led by DT Willis and DE Jackson has 20 sks incl 6 vs FSU and UVA has all'd 8 in their L/3 gms. We will call for the Canes to avoid the letdown and win by just over a td.

Toledo by 3 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - While UT is 17-1 vs EM winning 11 straight (8-3 ATS), they failed to cover the L/2 and only won 20-15 LY as a 13' pt HF. LW UT was without starting QB Guadagni (CS), who was inj'd the week prior. He was replaced by Illinois transfer QB Peters, who is more of a pocket passer compared to the dual threat QB Guadagni, who is UT's leading rusher. While Peters had a 3-0 ratio vs BG, he threw for just 184 yds as UT leaned on their run game with 3 RB's all having 79+ yds rush. While they won 52-36 they failed to cover vs rival BG as a 22 pt HF. EM is off their 3rd straight 3 pt loss but is 2-1 ATS in those gms and did pull the outright upset over Purdue as a 13 pt AD TY. EM has struggled vs the run allowing 213 ypg (5.0 ypc), while UT is avg 196 ypg (4.6 ypc) on the ground. That points to a UT outright upset win.

Texas A&M by 5 over SOUTH CAROLINA - SC is 0-4 SU vs A&M but they've covered the L/3.

Part of the game was played in a monsoon and both the clocks and headsets were knocked out. SC was outgained by 113 yds but Mizzou squandered 4 trips inside the RZ and SC kicked a gm winning 33 yd fg. A&M has held 3 of their opponent's to their ssn low yards and allow just 79 (3.0) rush ypg. RB Trayveon Williams has 720 (5.8) on the ssn and SC, who is still missing All-SEC LB DJ Wonnum, just allowed 286 (6.2) rushing vs MO. The Gamecocks have won 6 of their L/7 gms decided by a td or less and are 8-2 as doos but A&M has covered 4 of their L/5 road gms.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 4 over UIm - LY was their first meeting and CCU trailed ULM 45-30 but scored a td w/3:07 left to within two points. On the final play CCU fumbled and the Warhawks ret'd it for a td with :00 left to win by 51-43. ULM is just 1-6 ATS in their L/7 SBC gms and just got torched by Ole Miss for 70 pts and 826 yards (517 pass yds). CCU has a solid situational edge as they are at home off a bye while ULM is playing in their 5th road game in 6 weeks and the Warhawks are just 4-21 SU in their past 35 road gms. CCU is more of a running team (242 rush ypg) than a pass team (176 pass ypg) but ULM's defense is reverting back to their 2017 form and CCU is on a 4-2 ATS run in SBC play, CCU QB Anderson was out in their last gm w/ an inj, but had the bye to heal up and could be back for this one.

Purdue by 6 over ILLINOIS - The Purdue Cannon is at stake & it's homecoming in Champaign. This is IL's lone HG in a 5 wk stretch. PU enters off a bye & is on a 4-1 ATS series run. Since taking over full-time vs Mizzou, David Blough is avg nearly 400 pass ypg w/a 7-1 ratio & an aggressive PU has finished with the most yards all'd by 3 of their foes. After losing their F/3 gms by a comb'd 8 pts, PU has beaten BC & Neb by double-digits. IL snapped their 13 gm B10 losing streak at Rutgers, but finished +33 yds. QB AJ Bush returned from a 2 gm absence & while he compl just 10-18-89-1-0, he ran for 116 (6.4) & RB Reggie Corbin added a car high 137 (12.5). PU has all'd 233+ rush in 2 of their L/3 gms & IL is avg 261 (5.6) rush ypg. We're aware that PU HC Brohm is 4-1 ATS off a bye, but IL led USF 4Q & led PSU 3Q and is improving.

Ball St by 7 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - CM has won 3 straight in series but are just 1-3 ATS the L/4 yrs. LY Ball St without their top QB & top RB and CM won 56-9 as a 3 pt AF delivering us a late phone winner. LTH Ball St was down just 24-21 (+12') was int'd in the EZ with 1:38 left. Both teams lost to NIU by identical 24-16 scores but CM was a 14 pt AD while BSU was a 3 pt HD LW. Ball St trailed NIU 14-0 but did get within 21-16 mid-4Q led by QB Neal who is avg 250 ypg pass. We won a late phone selection LW going against CM as they lost to UB by 10 as a 7 pt HD. Ball St has a big offensive edge (#67-#122) as BSU QB Neal is avg 250 ypg pass while CM as a tm is avg just 270 ttl ypg.

MARYLAND by 17 over Rutgers - It's homecoming in College Park & MD is in revenge mode after losing LY as they were down to their #4 walk-on QB. MD enters off a physical loss at Michigan, being held to just 11 FD's & 220 yds. RU enters off a misleading 3 td loss vs IL as they were only outg'd by 33 yds (-3 TO's). True frosh QB Artur Sitkowski is getting more comfy as he compl 63% for a car high 267 yds. MD is on a 9-16 overall ATS run. RU is travelling for the 1st time in 4 wks & while they've lost both road gms SU TY, they were 4-1 as an AD LY.

Virginia Tech by 1 over NORTH CAROLINA - VT has blown NC out in each of the L/2, winning 34-3 LTH in a driving rainstorm and 59-7 (-20') LY. The Tar Heels finally have everyone back from susp, and enter fresh off a bye. Their loss 37 pt loss to Miami prior to the bye would have been much closer had it not been for 6 To's incl 3 defensive td's and they were only outgained by 25 yards. We went against VT in Blacksburg last week for our 4★ key selection on these pages (4★'s are 5-1 on the season, also 3★ LPS!) and picked up an easy winner in the Hokies 45-23 (+6') loss. NC's OFF is #39, avg 55 ypg more than their foes allow VT's young defense is #103, allowing 36 ypg more than their foes avg and their pass D, normally a Hokies' staple is #99 in our pass eff D ratings. The Hokies are 6-15 as an AF so we will call for NC to keep it closer than expected.

UC also enters off a bye and is playing their first home gm in 4 weeks. EC enters off their worst performance of the ssn, a blowout 49-6 loss at Temple, getting outgained 470-196! EC's defense had shown major improvement from LY, but all'd season highs in yards & FD's. UH is 1-8 as an AF & LY's final was misleading as EC finished w/a 33-16 FD edge. EC is improved despite LW's showing & will keep this closer than expected.

BUFFALO by 13 over Akron - The HT has won 7 straight going 5-1-1 ATS. LY's game had 5 lead changes & UB missed a 46 yd fg w/1:51 left and lost 21-20 (+1). After winning the MAC East LY and winning their first 2 gms TY, including upsetting Northwestern, the Zips have dropped 2 straight. LW vs Miami the Zips led 17-14 early 3Q but after S Alvin Davis was injured (CS) & ejected in 2H for targeting, the Zips allowed 27 unanswered being outgained 422-259, The Bulls after finishing 6-6 LY, have started 5-1 and LW were a Late Phone selection winner for us as they took care of CM 34-24 (-7). While Akron has a slight Def edge (#80-#87), UB has a huge edge on Off (#59-#114) led by QB Jackson (222 tpg, 17-4 ratio). We look for the Bulls to win here and become the first bowl eligible MAC team TY, as they keep in the hunt for TY's MAC East Title.

Marshall by 8 over OLD DOMINION - Marshall is 3-1 SU/ATS in this series. Last year Old Dominion entered this game having just taken a physical loss to FAU by 30 pts and lost 38-3 (-13'). This year ODU enters off a deceiving 29 pt loss (+13') vs FAU. The Monarchs trailed 32-27 AQ and put year ODU enters off a deceiving 29 pt loss (+13') vs FAU. HC Holiday is just 8-15 as an AF while ODU is 4-9 but did upset VT earlier this year in Norfolk.

Middle Tennessee by 2 over FIU - FIU has covered all 5 of their CUSA openers since joining in 2013. They've also won 4 straight CUSA home openers. Last year MT held a 298-89 yard edge at

FIU is fresh off a bye and last year Butch Davis' Panthers beat Marshall as a 16' pt dog off their bye. MT is off a Fri night road upset vs Marshall, 34-24 (+4). They trailed 17-10 and were being outgained 232-182 at half. QB Stockstill threw for 317 and has a 10-3 ratio this year. The Blue Raiders are in the driver's seat to win the CUSA East

MIAMI by 6 over Kent St - Home team has won 5 straight in series (4-1 ATS). LY MU led 14-3 at HT but lost 17-14 as a 9 pt AF. After opening 0-3 SU & ATS Miami has covered 3 straight conf gms, going 2-1 SU with the only loss being a 40-39 loss to WM. While KS is just 1-5 SU they are 4-2 ATS and are off their own heartbreaking 1 pt loss as they led MAC East Favorite, Ohio 26-21 late 4Q as a 12 pt HD but allowed a td with 1:28 left to lose 27-26. Miami has a huge experience edge (#6-#107) and are under a 5th yr HC Martin, while KS has made huge changes on both sides of the ball under 1st yr HC Lewis. KS looks to be headed in the right direction & will keep it close. UTAH ST by 20 over Univ - Utah St looks like the best team in the MW this ssn as their only loss this ssn was a 7 point loss at Mich St in Week 1 that they easily could have won. The Aggies offense is one of the best in the FBS, scoring 50 ppg and gaining 458 ypg. Utah St has won four straight gms SU vs UNLV by an avg of 16 ppg. Losing QB Armani Rogers was a tough blow for the Rebels, as he was in the top 10 in the country for rushing yds prior to his injury. Last week against New Mexico the offense only put up 14 pts and 166 total yds. UNLV is catching Utah St at the worst possible time, and their defense is better overall than the NM one that held them to 14 pts. While Utah St is ply'g extremely well, we feel this line is a bit too high to justify backing the Aggies. New Mexico by 3 over COLORADO ST - CSU has owned this series over the past decade, going 9-1s/2008 and have won 8 in a row against the Lobos. Last ssn the Rams were outgained 411-450 and held NM late to win 27-24. Both teams are off crucial MW wins as CSU scored 14 straight pts in the 4Q to win 42-30 on the road at SJSt while NM got a UNLV that had just lost

starting QB either. NM bkp QB Jones looks comfortable running the offense and HC Davie has opened up the pass gm more with him under center. Both teams put up over 400 ypg but allow well over 400 ypg, so a high scoring game could be in store. NM is on an 8-4 run as a dog in MW games and we think the Lobos pull out a close victory on the road in this one

Troy by 17 over LIBERTY - First ever meeting between these two schools. Troy is still waiting to see how starting QB Kaleb Barker is, as he left their Thurs night win over Georgia St in the 1H with an undisclosed inj. The Trojan run game picked up the slack as RB BJ Smith led w/ 140 yds and a pair of TD's. Troy is also 3-1 since the start of LY as an AF. Liberty's off B2B road gms in the state of New Mexico (went 1-1 SU) and are averaging 33 ppg and 489 yds on offense, but are allowing 37 ppg and 499 ypg on DEF. The Flames are on a 1-3 ATS run while Troy is on an impressive 10-3 ATS run. Barker's status will impact this game one way or the other, but we still like the road tm to come away with a comfy win

NOTRE DAME by 24 over Pittsburgh - There have been 6 outright upsets in the L/15 mtgs between these 2, with Pitt pulling 4 of them including twice in South Bend. We've rolled with the Irish each of the L/2 weeks as a key selection on these pages picking up a 4★ winner (also 3★ LPS) a week ago in their 45-23 (-6') win at VT. Pitt enters off a 44-37 (3') upset win in OT over Syracuse. The Panthers held QB Dungy to just 195 pass yds (47% compl) & 70 rush yds. Both RB's Ollison & Hall went for over 100 yds each with 192 & 107 respectively. QB Pickett has yet to top 200 passing yds this year. ND brings our #7 rated pass D that allows 56% compl (5-7 ratio). QB Book has thrown for 291 ypg and has a 8-1 ratio in his F/3 starts and Dexter Williams has rushed for 161 & 178 in his F/2 gms since ret'g from susp. We are on a roll backing ND and we will keep going as the Irish are 3-0 ATS since Book was inserted as the starter.

USC by 4 over Colorado - Following a 7 pt win over the Sun Devils a week ago in Boulder where they cashed a 2★ Newsletter Winner (25-18 FD & 494-367 yd edges), the Buffs head on the road to také on a Trojans squad that's won all 7 Pac-12 meetings (19 pt avg MÓV). The Trojans are well-rested following their bye week and are sitting at just 3-2 on the year. In LY's trip to Colorado, the #15 Trojans were able to clinch the P12 South with a 38-24 (-13') victory (USC ST's unit blk'd a pair of Colorado FG attempts). With the Buffs having covered 7 of their past 10 as an AD overall we'll back the Buff's.

Army by 17 over SAN JOSE ST - First meeting between these schools. Army gets this game off of a bye and in their prior game they traveled to Buffalo and won 42-13. SJSt is off B2B tough losses as they fell 44-41 to Hawaii in 5OT and then blew a 4Q lead against Colorado St. SJSt is 3-5 against the other 2 service academies incl a 21-0 win vs AF last ssn. SJSt's defense is allowing 488 ypg, incl 338 pass ypg. Army is still committed to the option attack, but may look to exploit the Spartans poor pass D. Army is 18-13 SU against non-service acad teams s/2016. Army's D is also allowing teams to gain just 354 yds & 22 ppg and we like Army to get to road win here.

Washington by 3 over OREGON - The Ducks had won 12 in a row both SU & ATS in the series before dropping each of the past 2 by 49 and 35 pts! While the Huskies knocked off the Bruins inside of the Rose Bowl for the 1st time since 1995, the game was much closer than expected (7 pt win) as the visitor was laying 3 TD's. The Ducks meanwhile are only a blown lead in their most recent home game against Stanford away from being undefeated heading in. While we'll go ahead and call for the Huskies to get their 3rd consec series victory in this one, they are playing a 4th road game in a span of 7 weeks. With the Ducks also rested following a bye, a 5 pt lean is all that we can give to the visitor. Louisiana Tech by 24 over UTSA - Last year LT needed to win to get to a bowl gm and they pulled out a 20-6 victory, holding UTSA to a ssn low 201 yds. UTSA is on a deceiving 3 game win streak, having beaten Texas St, UTEP & Rice (combined 0-14 vs FBS foes). The RoadRunners OFF has been pitiful in all 3 wins, putting up no more than 278 yds and last week they had just 178 vs Rice but were +4 TO's which led to 17 of UTSA's 20 pts. QB's Grundy and Gillins threw for just 43 yds against the #127 pass eff D! Now they take on a LT squad led by CB Amik Robertson and Jaylon Ferguson (6 sk). The Bulldogs were off their upset win over NT a week ago vs UAB and lost 28-7 (-8'). LT led 7-0 2Q and only trailed 14-7 4Q. UTSA is dead last in the FBS, avg 189 ypg below their opponent's avg. LT avg 417 ypg and a few weeks ago put up the most yards LSU has allowed all ssn. LT is 11-5 ATS on the road while UTSA is 0-8 ATS at home.

Western Michigan by 16 over BOWLING GREEN - BG has lost 4 of the last 5 but won their last mtg in '15, 41-27 as a 2' pt AF. It was tied at 27 before BG pulled away late. The Falcons are 1-5 SU & ATS with their only SU win being a come from behind 7 pt win over an FCS, EKU as a 13' pt HF. They did cover LW against rival Toledo but lost 52-36 as a 22 pt AD. That has many calling for HC Jinks to be fired, so the Falcons could be desperate here. After opening 0-2 vs two Power-5 foes, WM has won 4 straight but failed to cover in both their MAC gms as a 2' pt AF & 4' pt HF. BG is last in the FBS in rush D allowing 332 ypg (6.6 YPC!). WM has a solid run game avg 196 ypg

The Huskies have won 23 of the last 24 reg ssn gms vs MAC East foes S/10 but that 1 loss was to Ohio 26-21 as a 13 pt HF in their last mtg (15). This could be a preview of the MAC Championship game. Ohio is off a 4Q comeback 27-26 win over KS as a 12 pt AF scoring a GW td w/1:28 left. NIU is 3-0 in MAC play TY covering 2 straight, including a 24-16 win LW as they never trailed Ball St as a 3 pt AF, Ohio has the Off edge (#54-118) as they are 2nd in the MAC avg 36.8 ypg but NIU has the Def edge (#42-#121) as they are allowing a MAC best 23.7 ppg. We've won 3 straight Underdog POW's on these pages, all by outright upset and we'll side with Ohio to pull off the outright upset FORECAST: Ohio by 1 this week

ARKANSAS by 8 over Ole Miss - The Razorbacks have pulled off an amazing 4 straight upsets vs Ole Miss, incl LY when the Hogs trailed 31-7 at half and rallied to win 38-37 (+3). The Razorbacks enter off an expected beatdown by Bama but there were some positives that came out of the 34 pt loss. RB Boyd was impressive in RB Whaley's absence, rushing for 102 (6.8). QB Storey threw for 230 and only 1 int. We picked up a winner on our Early Bird POW (Button #9 Comp on Monday's) with Ole Miss smoking ULM 70-21 (-22'). The Rebels put up a ssn high 826 yds and all 3 of st'g WR's topped 100 yds. The Rebel's high powered offense won't have nearly as much success vs an Ark D that has held 3 of their foes to their lowest ypg and despite the lopsided score, the Hogs played Bama much tougher than Ole Miss did. Ole Miss is 7-16 as an AF and though it's been a rough ssn for Ark, we will call for HC Morris to get his first SEC win here.

MICHIGAN by 6 over Wisconsin - UW is on a 4-0 ATS series run. UM enters off a blowout over MD, as they led 42-14 & all'd a gbg td w/1:50 left. UW is off a misleading 17 point win vs Nebraska as they finished just +15 yards. UW enters this game with banged up secondary that will be further depleted by Saf Scott Nelson being susp for the 1H here. UM QB Shea Patterson is compl 69% w/a 13-4 ratio, while the defense leads the nation holding foes to 234 ypg less than their avg. UM has held each of their L/2 foes to under 40 rush yds & is #2 in our PDR. UM is home for the 5th time in

6 weeks, but we feel UW keeps this game within a td.

OHIO ST by 35 over Minnesota - These B10 rivals haven't met since 2015. OSU led Indy just 28-20 at the half in their 23 pt win LW. MN enters off an emotional 17 pt loss to rival lowa. MN trailed by just 7 mid 3Q. OSU leads the nation avg 193 ypg more than their foes allow as QB Dwayne Haskins is compl 72% w/a 25-4 ratio! In MN's lone road game they all'd 315 (8.5) rush at MD & LW all'd lowa QB Stanley to throw for 314 yds & a 4-1 ratio. Interesting to note that OSU is on an 0-8 ATS run the week after ply'g the Hoosiers, but is 8-3 as 20+ chalk, while MN is 1-5-2 as an AD. MN HC Fleck is recruiting to compete in the trenches vs B10 heavyweights but the Gophers hasn't reached that level yet.

NAVY by 3 over Temple - Navy has dropped both AAC meetings SU despite being chalk in each. TU has never beaten Navy 3 straight. Navy enters off an emotional loss at rival AF. They trailed 14-7 at the half, but was outscored 21-0 in the 2H & held to ssn lows in FD's (9) & yds (178). This is their 1st FBS home game 5 weeks. TU enters off a blowout over EC, finishing w/a 470-196 yd edge! QB Anthony Russo had his best game, completing 84% w/a 4-1 ratio. Navy counters with just our #112 ranked PDR. TU is defending the option for the 1st time TY, but held Navy to just 136 (2.6) rush LY. Navy is 5-1 as a HD & has dropped just 1 reg ssn HG SU the L4Y!

West Virginia by 10 over IOWA ST - WV is on a 4-0 SU/ATS run in this series. ISU returns home

following B2B away games and has a bye on deck. The 'Clones were without RB David Montgomery LW & bkp QB Zeb Noland was repl'd after 1 series with true frosh Brock Purdy, who led the outright upset in Stillwater (1 of 2 outright upset wins for our Big Dogs, which are 17-12 w/7 outright upsets L4WI). Purdsy showed off a strong arm, compl 78% w/a 4-1 ratio & also led w/84 (4.4) rush yds. Montgomery & QB Kyle Kempt could return this week (CS). WV enters off a 16 pt win over KU that would've easily been by much more if not for the uncharacteristic performance of Heisman hopeful QB Will Grier, who threw 3 int's in the RZ & also had a fumble. This is a matchup of strength vs strength. WV is avg 122 ypg more than their foes allow while ISU is holding foes to 110 ypg less than their avg. WV has a bye on deck & is 6-2 on the B12 road. Grier will have a much better performance vs an ISU defense that has just 3 int's.

NORTH TEXAS by 6 over Southern Miss - NT has won/covered the L/2 in this series incl LY when the Mean Green were +8 at SM and QB Fine threw for 366 as NT won by 15 pts. SM enters fresh off a bye, and gave Auburn all they could handle the week prior in a 24-13 (+27) road loss. Two weeks ago NT outgained LA Tech 427-359, but QB Fine and RB Easly got banged up and they lost by 2 pts. That was understandable. What isn't excusable is struggling to beat lowly UTEP who entered last week on a 17 gm losing streak. The game was tied 10-10 at half and NT had to get a late SOD to hold on for a 27-24 (-27) win. NT only held a +11 yd edge. QB Abraham has compl'd 71% with an

11-5 ratio and NT may be w/o their top CB again in Kemon Hall. SM is 4-1 as an AD.

NORTHWESTERN by 3 over Nebraska - It's homecoming in Evanston. NW is 5-2 ATS as B10 rivals, but the visitor is on a 5-0 ATS run. Nebraska is on the 2nd of B2B away games & is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks. They enter off a misleading physical loss at Wiscy as despite losing by 17, they were only outg'd by 15 yds. QB Adrian Martinez continues to look recovered from his early ssn knee inj, throwing for a car high 384 yds. NW counters with just our #74 ranked PDR, all'g 64% completions & has just 4 int's. NW enters off an emotional come-from-behind win at MSU. Down 5 late 3Q, the 'Cats took the lead w/:15 left 3Q, NW was outo'd 425-381. Nebraska is better than their record indicates as they've ply'd the toughest sked in the nation, while NW is off B2B physical games. Nebraska is 13-6-1 as a dog away from Lincoln.

lowa by 7 over INDIANA - These B10 rivals haven't met since 2015. Iowa enters off a 17 pt win at rival MN, finishing w/a 100 yd edge. QB Nate Stanley threw for 314 yds w/a 4-1 ratio. IU enters off a physical loss at OSU. Trailing just 28-20 at the half, IU was outscored 21-6 in the 2H & finished -203 yds. QB Peyton Ramsey did throw for 322 yds (3-0 ratio). This is the 2nd of B2B away games for lowa with MD on deck. Both of these schools offer above avg defenses so we expect a low scoring affair. Iowa is 14-2-1 as an AF, while IU is 2-5 as a HD.

AUBURN by 10 over Tennessee - These two have haven't met since 2013. Tenn has lost their L/15 games vs SEC West foes by 25 ppg. HC Pruitt certainly will take this game seriously having both played for and coached as DC at Bama. Tenn is fresh off a bye and the Vols played Georgia much better than the 38-12 final score indicates. It was just 24-12 4Q and UGA's first to came on a fluke 34 yd offensive fumble return. Auburn has been particularly unimpressive, avg just 364 ypg. The Tigers have been held under 100 rush yards in 3 straight for the first time since 1999. Tenn has actually held 2 of their 4 FBS foes to their lowest yards incl Georgia with 441. If the Vols get some of their OL issues fixed over the bye week they could make this a competitive game and we just can't back a struggling Auburn offense that avg just 364 ypg.

TECHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK......IOWA **Series Play of the Week.....** West Virginia SITUATIONAL PLAY OF THE WEEK NORTH CAROLINA

TEXAS by 10 over Baylor - UT is on a 3-0 SU/ATS run in the series, but hasn't won 4 in a row SU since winning 12 straight from 1998-'09. Both schools have byes on deck. Our Underdog POW scored its 3rd straight outright upset win on these pages & we upgraded the 'Horns to our top weekly $4 \pm \text{LPS}$ as UT won the RRR on a GW 40 yd fg w/:09 left. UT led 45-24 in the 4Q. BU enters off an emotional back-and-forth win vs KSU, hitting the 29 yd GW fg w/:08 left after a 76/12pl drive. BU was known for their offense under Art Briles & in year 2 under Matt Rhule is avg 108 ypg more than their foes allow! UT is 2-7 as a HF, while BU HC Rhule is 17-7 as a dog of 7.5+ points.

ALABAMA by 28 over Missouri - It's Homecoming in Tuscaloosa. This is Mizzou's 1st trip to Tuscaloosa, the last mtg was a 42-13 Bama win in the '14 SEC Title game. Last week Bama was laying by far their largest points (-35) as a road favorite under HC Saban. The Tide would have actually covered that number if not for an Ark td with :13 left. The Tide have scored 45+ points in all 6 games this year. Mizzou enters off a 37-35 (-2) loss at SC where they had to deal with monsoon conditions, broken clocks and headsets and a lengthy lightning delay. The Tigers held a 490-377 yd edge but squandered 4 RZ chances with fg's and TO's. QB Lock now has a 20-26 ratio vs P5 Bowl foes and a 60-9 ratio against all others. Now he faces our #1 pass eff D. Bama backers have been backdoored 3 straight weeks so and with MO's offense that possibility certainly exists here again so we will keep the line at 4 td's

Oklahoma St by 8 over KANSAS ST - KSU is on an 11-3 ATS run in this series. OSU is ply'g with revenge after losing at home LY despite being nearly 3 td chalk! Both schools have a bye on deck. OSU enters off a 6 pt home loss vs ISU, getting victimized through the air. KSU enters off an emotional back-and-forth loss at Baylor where they all'd the 29 yd GW fg w/:08 left. RB Alex Barnes ran for 250 (11.4) & Skylar Thompson returned as the st'g QB after coming off the bench the week prior. The Pokes still have an elite offense that is avg 101 ypg more than their foes allow. OSU is on the road for the 2nd time in 3 weeks & is 23-14-1 as an AF. KSU won't be able to match score-for-score here as their passing game is nearly nonexistent.

Uab by 12 over RICE - Last year UAB jumped out to 42-7 at halftime but the yards were only 305-256. Rice enters off a disappointing 20-3 (-1) home loss vs UTSA where they allowed just 178 yards. UAB pulled their 2nd consecutive outright upset, beating LT 28-7 with a 365-258 yard edge. QB Erdely completed just 8-24-136 and has completed just 55% with a 5-5 ratio. The Blazers are +122 ypg and their D is #36, allowing 66 ypg more than their foes avg. Rice is -77 ypg and their OFF is #120, avg 76 ypg less than their foes allow. The Blazers are much better at home and have lost both times they've been an AF the last two years, so we will try to ignore last week's poor performance by the Owls and give the dog a slight lean.

Georgia by 1 over LSU - This is Georgia's first trip to Death Valley since 2009. The Dawgs only had a 263-230 yd edge at halftime and led a week ago vs Vanderbilt. They dominated the 2nd half and won 41-13 (-25'). We went against LSU last week for a 3★ key selection on these pages and the Tigers fell in the Swamp to the Gators 27-19. This will be QB Burrow's toughest test to date, against UĞA's defense which ranks #4 in FBS, holding foes to 135 ypg below their ssn avg. CB DeAndre Baker is a potential #1DC. LSU has a stout D of their own which ranks #31, holding foes to 75 ypg below their avg. UGA is 6-3 as a AF. This is a rare spot for LSU as a HD & getting a full td has us leaning with LŠU.

LOUISIANA by 13 over New Mexico St - 13th meeting all-time, with LA holding a 7-5 edge in the series. NMSt is just 2-6 on the road against LA incl a 47-34 loss last ssn. NMSt tied the gm at 34 early 4Q, but were held scoreless the rest of the gm and LA won 47-34. LA is going to use their strong run game (229 rush ypg) to exploit the poor NMSt rush D (246 rush yds all'd per gm). NMSt is also just 4-13 SU on the road s/2016 and are on a 4-8 ATS run. Both defenses are giving up 450plus yds, but the LA offense is producing more and they get this game at home as NMŠt has to travel a far way for this game. We like the Ragin' Cajuns to win by double digits.

BYU by 13 over Hawaii - BYU is 10-1 in this series SU since 1993. Last time these 2 teams met was last ssn in Hawaii when never led in the game & BYU won 30-20. BYU was ranked in the top 25 just 2 weeks ago, but after 2 ugly losses (outscored by Wash & Utah St 80-27) they have taken a step back. Hawaii is 6-1 and already reached bowl eligibility, but barely won last week after starting QB McDonald was a late scratch due to an inj. UH has not beaten a team w/ a winning record this ssn and is 2-4 as an AD, while BYU is on a 6-4 overall ATS run. UH's offense is good, but their defense is less than stellar (410 ypg all'd, 29.6 ppg all'd) and we will take BYU.

FRESNO ST by 14 over Wyoming - Fresno holds a slight 6-5 SU lead in this series & have won 3 of the past 4 gms SU with the avg MOV in those wins being 24 pts. Last year this gm was played in sloppy conditions and Fresno left win a 13-7 road win. Fresno is on an 16-6-1 ATS run while WY is just 2-7 ATS in their L/9 gms. The Fresno St offense is putting up over 400 ypg and 40 ppg, while

holding foes to just 317 yds & 16 ppg. The Pokes still rely heavily on their defense, as their offense is only putting up 293 ypg & 17.5 ppg. WY is 29-14 as an AD & will keep it closer than expected.

Boise St by 21 over NEVADA - Boise has owned this series, winning 15 out the past 16 gms (NEV lone win was in 2010 by 3 pts). Last ssn Boise jumped out to a 31-14 HT lead and easily won 41-14. Boise looks to rebound after a tough 19-13 home loss to San Diego St, while Nevada was without starting QB Gangi and scored just 3 pts against Fresno. Boise struggles at home ATS as they are just 5-16 as a home favorite s/2015, but performs well ATS on the road as an away favorite, as they are 16-8 s/2014. If Nev QB Gangi is unable to play, that significanly hurts Nev's chances to compete. Boise's offense will be eager to rebound and face a Wolf Pack team that gives up 34 ppg.

While the Chargers were able to earn a 19-10 win (-14) LY at home against the winless Browns, it was the '16 matchup in CLE that was clearly the more memorable contest with the Browns earning their 1st victory of the year following a late missed FG by the visitor (Chargers 356-251 yd edge). While the Chargers are on an impressive 9-3 ATS run as a NDIV AF coming in, we like CLE here as they could actually be sitting at 5-0 on the year had it not FORECAST: CLEVELAND by 6 been for some lackluster performances from their ST's. 3★ Pittsburgh over CINCINNATI - After a dominating home performance against the Falcons where we earned an easy Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner (24 pt victory as 3 pt chalk), the Steelers head to CIN having covered 9 of the past 13 as a DIV AD. The Bengals meanwhile upped their SU & ATS mark to 4-1 on the year following a 10 pt home victory over the Dolphins (3★ Newsletter Winner) with 2 defensive TD's sparking the come-from-behind win (CIN trailed 17-0 in 3Q). While the Bengals have covered 6 of their past 8 inside of the AFC North, leaning in the direction might not be the smartest of calls in this one as not only has PIT won 6 straight matchups in this series (incl playoffs) by 8 ppg, but they can also go all out here with a bye FORECAST: PITTSBURGH by 4 week on the horizon.

2★ TENNESSEE over Baltimore - Following a 2nd DIV loss of the ssn LW in OT against CLE, the Ravens heads South to take on a Titans squad that failed to get in the EZ for the 2nd time this ssn (BUF 46 yd GW FG on final play). In their Wk 9 matchup of a yr ago, the Ravens got a TD w/:46 left to pull within 3 for the backdoor ATS push (BAL 341-257 yd edge). With BAL a bit road weary with their 3 consec matchup away from home and the dog winning outright in each of the past 4 TEN matchups, we'll go ahead and call for the Titans to claim yet another home upset as they're on an 11-3-1 ATS run off a SU loss. FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 4 **OTHER PLAYS**

Philadelphia at NY GIANTS - Thursday - The Eagles' struggles as a favorite continued LW at home against the Vikings (1-6-1 ATS run as chalk) with MIN earning the 2 pt victory. Although the Giants were able to surpass the 30 pt mark for the 1st time in the L/36 gms in their come-frombehind attempt in CAR (took lead w/1:08 left), the Panthers stormed back hitting on a 63-yd FG as time expired (33-31 win). While it's not surprising that the Eagles won both contests a year ago with their 13-3 overall mark and the Giants a franchise-worst 3-13, PHI also earned the sweep in 2 of the 3 years prior (9 pt avg MOV from '14-'17). However, with the Giants at 6-3 ATS as a DIV HD and PHI failing to cover 6 of their past 8 as an AF, check back on Thursday to see which way we decide to lean. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday. MINNESOTA by 14 over Arizona - After earning some much-needed revenge LW in PHI (blown out in LY's NFC Championship) behind a 30-37, 301 yd performance from QB Cousins (WR Thielen 100+ rec yds in each of 1st 5 gms TY), the Vikings return home where they've covered 16 of their past 20 as a HF. The Cardinals delivered their 1st victory of the '18 campaign LW in SF despite significant FD (32-9) and yd (448-220) deficits (SF 5 TO's). Following an embarrassing performance in their last home matchup against the Bills (27-6 loss as 16' pt favorite), expect the Vikings to be much more focused this time around against a Cardinals squad (3-8 ATS as an AD) that's still in seach of finding consistency on the offensive side of the ball (211 ypg, last in NFL) Chicago by 4 over MIAMI - The Bears return from their bye week as one of the most improved teams in the NFL. Had it not been for their 2H collapse in the opener vs GB, CHI would be one of 3 undefeated teams remaining in the NFL. While the Dolphins showed some potential early on with a 3-0 start to the year, their results over the past 2 weeks have been poor to say the least with a 38-7 loss to NE (Sept NFL GOM Winner) and a blown 17-pt lead LW in CIN (3★ Newsletter Winner on the Bengals). In their most recent meeting back in '14 inside of Soldier Field, the Dolphins (+3) earned the 27-14 win with solid FD (24-14) and yardage (393-224) edges. With CHI covering all 4 of their non-conf matchups a year ago in what ended up being just a 5-win season, the smart money is on the Bears to get the victory here against an overrated MIA squad. Carolina by 3 over WASHINGTON - After a GW 63-yd FG on the final play of regulation LW in a Charlotte (CAR blew a 27-16 lead in the 4Q), the Panthers head to D.C. where they need a win to stay near the top of the NFC South standings. The Redskins are back in action following a MNF visit to the Superdome against the Saints. The most recent matchup in this series also happened to be on MNF back in '16 with the Panthers earning a 26-15 road victory as a 6' pt dog (CAR 438-335 yd edge). While WAS did collect a win in their last HG against the Packers a few weeks back, the Panthers 7-1 ATS mark as an AD is too much to pass on against a team on short rest.

NY JETS by 4 over Indianapolis - After a dominant offensive performance LW at home against the Broncos where they put up 34 pts & 512 yds, the Jets play host to a Colts squad on extra rest following their Thur Night loss in Foxboro where they finished with a 439-438 yd edge in the 14 pt defeat (QB Luck 38-59-365 yds & 3-2 ratio). In their NY matchup back in 16, the Colts (+1') claimed the easy MNF victory (led 41-3 in 4Q) with a 421-250 yd edge. While the Jets have covered just 2 of their past 6 coming in, we'll go ahead and give them the small

lean here as the Colts have become extremely banged up during their 3-game losing skid.

ATLANTA by 7 over Tampa Bay - Following a 3rd straight defeat LW against the Steelers (allowed 40 ppg during losing skid) where we earned an easy Top Weekly LP Winner, the Falcons return home sitting at just 1-4 on the year with their playoff hopes on life support. While the Bucs did begin the '18 campaign with a 2-0 mark, they've lost some of their Fitzmagic in the past 2 with a loss to PIT on MNF and a blowout defeat in the "Windy City" against the Bears. The Bucs return from their week off (8-3 ATS off a bye) with Winston expected to regain the duties as starting QB (16-20-145 1-2 ratio in relief of Fitzpatrick vs CHI). While the Falcons are on a 10-19 ATS run as a HF heading in, we have confidence in them here with 3 consec victories over TB by 10 ppg. † Seattle by 5 over Oakland - London. The Seahawks saw their 2-gm winning streak snapped at home a week ago against the Rams in a closer than expected final (2 pt loss as 7' pt dog). The Raiders meanwhile dropped to 1-4 on the year following a 16 pt loss to the Chargers where they had 19-12 FD and 412-289 yd deficits (former SEA RB Lynch held to just 31 rush yds). OAK made one prior visit to London back in 14 with the Dolphins earning an easy 38-14 (-3) win. While the Seahawks do make their 1st trip across the pond, they are an outstanding 6-1 ATS prior to their bye week. With the Raiders having covered just 2 of their past 12 matchups (2 ties) against the NFC coming in, we'll give the slight lean to the Seahawks in this one.

HOUSTON by 13 over Buffalo - After snapping their 9-game losing skid was snapped a few weeks back against the Colts, the Texans picked up a 2nd consec victory LW at home against the Cowboys in OT (HOU commanding 25-14 FD & 462-292 yd edges). The Bills meanwhile earned their 2nd win of the year in dramatic fashion with a 46-yd FG as time expired (3★ LP Winner on the Under 40, BUF & TEN combined for just 25 pts & 444 yds). In their most recent matchup back in '15, the hometown Bills picked up the 30-21 victory (-3) despite HOU holding the 401-390 yardage edge. With the BUF offense clearly not as dangerous as they were in that last contest (avg just 12.6 ppg & 221 ypg on the year) and the Texans posting a 10-4 ATS mark as a NDIV HF, we'll be happy to lay the points in this one.

LA Rams by 10 over DENVER - Following a blowout loss LW in NY against the Jets where

their defense was gashed for 34 pts and 512 yds, the Broncos are back home for the only time in a 4-wk span (at ARZ & at KC on deck) having gone just 1-3-1 ATS in the past 2 years against the NFC. The Rams meanwhile are in the 2nd of 3 consec road trips after a nail-biting win over SEA (5-0 for 1st time since 2001). In their last "Mile High" matchup against the Chiefs on MNF, the Broncos blew a DD 4Q lead at home for the 1st time since 2004! While we don't expect the Rams to be trailing in this one with covers in 5 of their L/6 against the AFC, DEN's poor overall ATS run (2-14-1) gives us even more confidence with the visitor.

Jacksonville by 1 over DALLAS - After a 3 pt OT loss LW against HOU in the Battle of Texas (DAL opted to punt on 4&1 from the HOU42 with 5:33 left in OT?), the Cowboys return home where they've picked up their only 2 victories of the ssn against the Giants and Lions. In a key early ssn battle in the AFC against the Chiefs, a 23-0 deficit was too much for JAX to overcome in the eventual 16 pt defeat (Bortles 4 int's). With the Jaguars routinely struggling in matchups against the NFC with just a 4-18 ATS mark, we'll be leaning with the home dog in this one as DAL is 10-5-1 ATS in their non-conf battles.

Kansas City at NEW ENGLAND - SNF - In their Thur night matchup to kick off the season a year ago, the Chiefs shocked the nation with a dominant 2H in Foxboro that saw them outscore the defending champs by a 28-10 margin en route to a 42-27 victory (KC 537-371 yd edge). The start to the Chiefs '18 campaign has been just as magical as their 16 pt win LW in Arrowhead against the Jags has them undefeated and atop the AFC. Following their Thur night win against the Colts where Brady threw for 341 yds & 3 TD's, the Patriots are back over the .500 mark at 3-2. While KC is on a 9-0 ATS run heading in, NE has their own impressive ATS mark (12-3) and is clearly seeking revenge from LY's embarrassing upset. Call the office on Sunday after

11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!
San Francisco at GREEN BAY - MNF - The 49ers and Packers are a pair of franchises rich in history and Super Bowl glory with 9 combined Lombardi Trophies. These 2 have also seen plenty of memorable playoff matchups dating back to 1995 with GB holding a slim 4-3 advantage. While Jimmy Garoppolo is expected to be the next great QB for SF, an ACL injury a few wks back has seen CJ Beathard start the past 2 weeks including a home loss LW against the previously winless Cardinals (SF 32-9 FD & 448-220 yd edges, -5 TO's). The Packers meanwhile were unable to overcome a 24-0 HT deficit LW in DET despite an outstanding effort from QB Rodgers (442 yds, 3-0 ratio). In their most recent contest back in '15, the Packers claimed a 17-3 victory in SF behind a defense that allowed just 8 FD's and 196 yds.
