## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ UAB over Rice** - UAB has won 4 straight mtgs and had 3 straight wins by 15+ points before LY when they only won 21-16 (-7). The home team in this series is 6-3 SU/8-1 ATS. These teams had polar opposite performances LW. We won a 3★ LPS on UAB last week in the Blazers' 34-0 win over SMiss. UAB had a 275-62 yd edge and led 31-0 at half. 2 weeks ago Rice was out'd by that same SMiss squad and only won 24-19. Rice was crushed 45-0 at UTSA LW. They were outgained by 294-53 in the 1H and trailed 31-0 themselves. UAB holds foes 49 ypg below their avg (#49 in FBS) while Rice avg 96 ypg less than their foes avg (#129 in FBS). The Blazers are 16-6-1 ATS at home we don't mind laying big points against Rice who has 3 losses by 37 points or more and are -234 ypg on the road so take the Blazers!

**FORECAST: UAB by 34**

**3★ TCU over West Virginia** - As B12 foes WVU has won 4 of the L/5 gms SU and have covered all 5 gms. LY WVU (-3) hosted TCU and held them to 295 yds in a 24-6 win (WVU +2 TO's). WVU is off a bye after dropping their first three B12 games, but 2 of those losses were by 3 pts to OU and TTech. TCU is off a 52-31 loss to OU (2★ PS winner on OU) but WR Johnston had a coming out party (185 yds, 3 td). WVU's offense has only avg'd 337 ypg/18 ppg against B12 foes and their run gm is only avg'g 77 ypg (2.5) in conf play. However TCU has all'd 267 rush ypg (6.1) the L/4 gms & their D overall is giving 523 ypg/39 ppg the L/4 gms. TCU's rush offense has been their strength this ssn (235, 5.7) led by RB Evans (586, 7.9) but WVU's rush D has given up just 102 (3.0). Off a bye we think WVU puts up a solid effort, but TCU is 5-2 ATS off a SU loss & WVU is 1-4 ATS in their L/5 road gms.

**FORECAST: TCU by 13**

**3★ ALABAMA over Tennessee** - Bama is 14-0 SU/11-4 ATS and the Tide have won the L/5 by 33 ppg. The Tide picked up a rare ATS cover off a loss last week when they crushed Miss St 49-9 (-17) and finished w/a 543-299 yd edge. Tenn lost to that same Ole Miss squad at home 31-26 (-2). QB Hooker has a 14-1 ratio and ran for 108 last week but left with a painful injury for the last 2 plays and the Vols also lost RT Mays early. Bama should have no problem stopping the up-tempo high powered Vols offense considering they held Ole Miss to a ssn low 291 yds and led 35-0 before allowing 21 points in garbage time. The Tide are holding foes 130 ypg below their avg (#5 in FBS). Last week's loss took a lot out of Tenn and they won't have any golf balls to throw at Saban on the road so we think Bama routes a physically tired Tennessee team that desperately needs their bye week.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ East Carolina (+) over HOUSTON** - Houston has won the last 2 mtgs but the Pirates are 3-1 ATS the previous decade vs. the Cougars. ECU has played the much tougher schedule (#74 vs. #119) TY, w/ Houston's only gm as an underdog vs a then 1-win Tulsa on the road (+3), a gm the Cougars dominated 45-10 3 wks ago. The Pirates are 7-3 as an AD under HC Mike Houston, and are 3-0 ATS vs. FBS tms since their defeat at home to South Carolina (+2) on a GW FG w/ 0:00 left, 20-17. The Cougars' sack rate ballooned to 18% after recording 8 vs. a decimated Tulane O-line, a gm they still found themselves trailing 22-17 in the 3Q before pulling away late on the road (-6), 40-22. ECU had no trouble w/ Tulane in their mtg, racing to a 31-7 HT lead in a 52-29 drubbing as a HD (+3). The Pirates are better than their 3-3 record and all 5 of Houston's wins have come against weak foes (all under .500) so we will gladly take the points.

**FORECAST: Houston by 6**

**2★ Colorado St over UTAH ST** - CSU has covered 4 straight in series. CSU is on the road again as they played NMex LW & we picked up a 2★ PS winner & a 3★ LP winner on the Rams as they won 36-7 (452-79, only TD all'd was PR TD) while USU is off a game at UNLV where they scored the GW TD with :35 left. USU's offense has put up 462 ypg the L/4 gms incl passing for 317 ypg but they face a CSU D that is holding foes to just 286 ypg/13 ppg the L/4 gms & the Rams have 18 sks the L/4 gms. On the other hand CSU's offense is putting up 452 ypg against MW foes and they have ran for 178 ypg the L/5 gms & USU's D has given up 464 ypg the L/4 gms and over the L/4 gms their run D has all'd 256 ypg (5.9). We'll side with the stronger defense to help lead CSU to a win & the Rams are on a 4-0 ATS run while USU is on a 3-14 ATS slide as a home dog.

**Coastal Carolina at APPALACHIAN ST** - App St is 3-1 SU against CCU with the lone loss for App St coming LY when CCU was outgained by 49 yds but were +2 TO's incl a pick-six to put the gm away. CCU last played 13 days ago at Ark St where they gained 685 yds in a 52-20 win while App St is off a gm 8 days ago where they were drubbed 41-13 at LA (211-455) and were -3 TO's. App St has faced the tougher schedule (#61 vs #129). CCU is rushing for 262 ypg (6.6) and App St just all'd 246 rush (5.6) to LA. CCU's D has all'd just 282 ypg/15 ppg but the App St offense put up over 500 yds in their 3 gms prior to LA but RB Peoples has missed the L/2 gms. QB McCall is hitting 80% (1478, 14-1) but App St's #40 pass D is the best CCU has faced TY. CCU is 4-2 ATS the L/3Y as an AF but App St is a desperate team at home in front of their fans and they need a win here if they want a shot at making the SBC title game. ### THURSDAY, OCTOBER 21ST

**SMU by 21 over Tulane** - The Mustangs lead the series 14-13 but won 6 straight (4-2 ATS). Tulane has been outscored by 63 pts in their last two road gms, all'g an avg of 57 ppg. For a tm that looked promising in a spirited comeback attempt vs. Oklahoma in Norman (+32) in their opener w/ a chance to win on their final drive (lost 40-35), the Green Wave have fallen completely flat, including in their last gm at home vs. Houston (+6). They showed enough determination to take a 22-17 lead early 3Q, but the O-line all'd 8 sacks and the Cougars pulled away for a 40-22 win, handing Tulane their 4th loss in a row SU and ATS. The Wave are all'g 68% pass completions TY and face the nation's pass TD leader in Mordecai (1894, 71%, 26/7), though both tms are off a bye.

**Louisiana by 24 over ARKANSAS ST** - LA is 6-2 SU/5-3 ATS against Ark St. Ark St last play'd 2 wks ago against Coastal & they gave up 685 yds & lost 52-20. LA had a couple extra days of rest following their big win against App St where they won 41-13 (455-211) and forced 4 TO's! LA is running for 228 ypg (5.6) the L/4 gms and face an Ark St run D giving up 326 ypg (7.0) the L/4 gms. LA QB Lewis is a capable passer too & the Ark St pass D (#123) is all'g 390 pass ypg in their L/4 gms vs non option tms. Ark St's offense has thrown for 357 ypg & LA's pass D ranks just #113 but Ark St OL has all'd 16 sks the L/3 gms & Cajuns have a solid pass rush (7 sks L/3 gms). It is tough to see Ark St & their swiss cheese defense being able to stop LA at all & we'll take the Cajuns by over 3 tds.

**Fau by 10 over CHARLOTTE** - FAU has won the last 2 in this series but last year they trailed 10-0 and were outgained 165-72 in the 1H. The Owls rallied to win 21-17 but the 49ers were +5 and gave us 3★ LPS and Underdog POW winners. Both tms are fresh off a bye. UC is -43 ypg and their D has allowed 448 ypg and 126 ypg more than their foes avg (#128 in FBS). FAU is +66 ypg and puts up 44 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. QB Perry is hitting 60% w/a 11-4 ratio and UC has the #109 pass D that just gave up 466 pass yards to FIU. The 49ers were outgained vs the Panthers by 160 yds in a 12 point win prior to the bye while FAU beat FIU 58-21 and was +316 yds. The 49ers are 10-3 as home dogs but FAU has a big talent edge.

**San Jose St by 3 over UNLV** - As MW foes SJSU is 6-2 SU/ATS against UNLV & the home team has covered 5 straight meetings in this series. After their MW title LY this ssn has been a disappointment for SJSU as they are just 3-4 on the year (1-5 ATS vs FBS foes) & their offense is putting up 73 ypg

under what their foes usually allow (#123 FBS) & while UNLV's defense is all'g 452 ypg they are holding foes to 11 ypg under their ssn avg. UNLV's biggest issue on offense is their instability at the QB position as 3 different players have started a gm & the offense is avg'g just 290 ypg. SJSU does have a stable D that is all'g 351 ypg this ssn and while their run D has all'd just 131 ypg (3.6) UNLV's best player on offense is RB Williams (625, 5.2) had a career day LW as he ran for 221 (8.2) with 3 td's. UNLV has shown a lot lately as their L/3 offenses are all by 8 pts or less (4-1 ATS run as underdogs) and we think they can stay close with SJSU who could still be w/o starting QB Starkel.

### FRIDAY, OCTOBER 22ND

**Middle Tennessee by 20 over CONNECTICUT** - Last mtg was back in '01. MT won 38-14. MT is fresh off a bye and this is a must win for bowl eligibility. UConn ended their 11 game losing streak by beating FCS Yale 21-15. Interim HC Spanos returned after missing the prior game due to Covid. The Huskies led 21-0 3Q but allowed Yale to score 15 unanswered and ended the game on the UConn 30. MT is -107 ypg and they've played our #68 toughest schedule while UConn is -179 ypg but have played our #124 toughest schedule. With MT still needing 4 wins to get bowl eligible and they've only got 1-6 SMiss on deck (also 0 wins vs FBS), we see the Blue Raiders winning by more than 2 tds.

**UCF by 6 over Memphis** - The Golden Knights have dominated this matchup (13-2 all-time), winning 13-straight before Memphis stopped the bleeding LY w/ a 50-49 win at home (+3) after UCF missed a potential 40-yd GW FG w/ :20 sec left. The Knights held a 798-703 yd edge but the Tigers were +7 FD (41-34). UCF QB Gabriel threw for 601 yds and 5 TDs in defeat but broke his clavicle earlier this yr and remains out indefinitely. The Knights are still w/o their top WR and lost starting DT Davis for the yr 2 wks ago. We noticed a 3★ Late Phone Winner LW on UCF's dismantling at the hands of Cincinnati on the road, 56-21 (+21), after they fell behind 35-0 in the 1H and to 0-5 ATS vs. the FBS TY. Memphis rebounded LW after losing 3 in a row SU and ATS w/ a 35-17 win at home over Navy (-11) but we think the Knights showed some fight in the 2H LW and will win by nearly a td.

**Washington by 20 over ARIZONA** - Following a narrow 7 pt home win against the Bruins where outgained by a 420-267 yd clip, the Huskies head to the desert to take on a Wildcats squad that remains winless after a 34-0 defeat in Boulder where the Buffs held them to just 280 yds. Arizona has dropped the L/4 against the Huskies (1-3 ATS) including LY when they fell behind 24-0 at HT and 37-0 after 3Q before scoring 27 pts in the 4Q to only lose by 17 (+11'). With the Wildcats on the nation's longest losing streak (18 straight losses!) and failing to cover 5 of their L/7 as a HD coming in, the Huskies (HF for 1st time in 3Y) should have no issue picking up the win and cover in this one.

### SATURDAY, OCTOBER 23RD

**TOLEDO by 3 over Western Michigan** - HT is 4-1 SU & ATS. LY Toledo (+2) led 38-28 w/2:54 left, but allowed 2 td's in final :45 & lost 41-38. WM bounced back LW, literally running over (341 rush yd, 6.7 ypc) Kent St 64-31 finishing with a 648-362 yd edge. Rockets (-5) never led vs CM LW, but scored 10 pts in final :43 to send game to OT. They missed their fg att & CM hit their handing UT a 36-23 loss. Because of LW results WM has opened as an AF, but will not find as much success on offense as UT has our #43 defense, while LW foe, Kent St is #119. UT has not been a HD s/19, when they beat BYU 28-21 (+2). UT beat Ball St 22-12 as a 5 pt AD finishing with a 444-312 yd edge, WM lost as a 12 pt HD to Ball St 45-20 but had a 376-375 yd edge. At 1-2 in MAC play UT can not afford a loss here & will pull out all the stops here with a bye on deck.

**FLORIDA ST by 35 over UMass** - FSU suddenly has renewed life having won B2B games over Cuse & NCar prior to their bye. The 'Noles actually led the Tar Heels on the road 35-17 late 4Q but got outgained by 49 yards and are only -29 ypg on the season. UMass is also fresh off a bye following their first win of the season which actually resulted in fans storming the field because they beat 0-5 powerhouse UConn. The Minutemen are -186 ypg but did stay closer than expected against ACC foe Boston College earlier this year but were also crushed 51-7 at Pitt in their opener. UMass' last 2 losses were by 50 at Coastal Carolina and by 38 at home vs Toledo. FSU lost as 26 pt chalk earlier TY against FCS Jacksonville St so they won't mess around and need a big dominant victory.

**GEORGIA ST by 13 over Texas St** - TXSt leads the series 4-3 & have won the L/2 gms SU against GSU. Both tms sit at 2-4 this ssn but GSU is better than their record & have played a much tougher schedule (#52 vs #119). GSU is off a bye & in their last gm they thrashed ULM 55-21 while TXSt is off a gm against Troy. GSU's offense has gotten going under new QB Grainger (443 ypg L/4 gms) incl rushing for 256 yds (5.2) in their past 4 gms. TXSt was down as many as 24 players earlier this ssn (covid/inj's) but are close to 100% and their D has all'd just 358 ypg the L/2 gms. GSU's D has had its ups & downs but over the L/4 gms have all'd 389 ypg and they face a TXSt D that is getting held to 37 ypg under what their foes typically allow (#101 FBS). TXSt is just 5-8 ATS under HC Spavital as an AD & GSU is on a 5-1 ATS run as the favorite. GSU got rolling on offense in their last gm & with a week off to prep for this game we think the Panthers will come out & win by nearly 2 tds.

**Ohio State by 27 over INDIANA** - A lopsided series, as the Buckeyes are 76-12-5 all-time vs. Indiana, having won 25 consecutive gms. Ohio St is 7-1-1 ATS as AF under HC Day and are off a bye, while Indiana's grueling schedule (#16 toughest in FBS) won't let up as they now face the top offense in the nation on the road (563 ypg). The Buckeyes are 3-0 ATS, all as DD favs, beginning w/ the decision to rest banged up QB CJ Stroud vs. Akron (1699, 66%, 18/3). Ohio St is 5-1 ATS in the previous 18 mtgs when laying less than 20 pts, while the Hoosiers are 4-8 ATS as HD under HC Allen. LY the Buckeyes (-20) led 28-7 at home (389-191 yd edge) by HT and 42-21 end 3Q, before Indiana fought back to narrowly lose 42-35. QB Penix dazzled (491, 53%, 5/1), but DNP LW and is not expected back for this gm. We see Ohio St taking this one by nearly 4 TDs.

**Buffalo by 7 over AKRON** - Bulls have won 3 straight SU & ATS outscoring Zips by a comb 101-13. LW Akron (+20) trailed Miami 14-0 after 1Q & 4-7 into 4Q but scored 14 unanswered incl a 50 yd td pass w/:31 left for the backdoor cover. Akron was down to 3rd string QB Gibson vs Miami but then threw for a car high 291 w/3-0 ratio. LW UB (-7) trailed 21-0 after 1Q & 26-10 into 4Q but scored 17 unanswered incl GW fg on final play for a 27-26 win over Ohio. UB QB Vantrease is avg 206 ypg pass but with just a 5-4 ratio. UB finished with a 373-346 yd edge over Ohio. Akron early TY led Ohio 17-10 in 3Q but lost QB Irons to injury. UA allowed L/24 incl a td w/1:16 left to lose 34-17 as a 9 pt HD being outgained 458-327. Still UB's only cover vs FBS TY was as a 14 pt HD vs CC. UA has covered 2 straight as DD dog & are a dropped late td pass from that being 3 straight.

**PENN ST by 28 over Illinois** - PSU is 20-5 SU and 3-0 ATS vs. the Illini S/15 w/ an avg scoring margin of 38 ppg. LY, also in Happy Valley (-15), PSU exploded for 3 plays of 70+ yds (school record) w/+307 yds and a 28-12 FD edge that culminated in a ssn-high 56 pts and led to a 35-pt romp of Illinois. Our lean is contingent on QB Clifford playing in this gm after getting knocked out 2 wks ago in the 2Q on the road vs. Iowa (+1) w/ Penn St up 17-3 before all'g a comeback in his absence. His top target Jahan Dotson (494, 11.5) has at least 5 rec in every gm this ssn and a min of 7 in his last 4. Dotson looks to rebound vs. the #80 ranked pass D after being held scoreless for the first time all ssn at Iowa. The Illini are 1-5 ATS as DD dogs and if Clifford's in we like the Nittany Lions by 4 TDs.

**VIRGINIA by 3 over Georgia Tech**- The home team has dominated this series, going 19-4-1 SU/16-6-1 ATS but the visitor has covered the L/2. The last 3 meetings have been decided by just 12 total points. GT enters fresh off a bye. The Jackets got a GW td with :51 left at Duke the week prior to win 31-27 (-4). UVA posted a shutout against that same Duke team, winning 48-0 and holding a +203 yd edge. QB Armstrong threw for 364 and has topped 300 in 6 of 7 starts with a 19-6 ratio. The Jackets have the edge on D while UVA has the edge on offense. UVA is 20-3 SU at home but last year GT pulled an outright upset over L'ville coming off their bye. We won't call for an upset here but we do think GT keeps this within a fg.

**Boston College by 3 over LOUISVILLE** - BC has covered 4 straight mtgs with 3 SU wins over L'ville. After starting 4-0 against weak competition, BC has now lost B2B games following a 33-7 (+3) loss at home vs NCSt. BC did only trail 10-7 at half and allowed a fumbled punt snar ret'd for td, a 79 yd td pass and a safety in the 2H. BC also dropped a td that led to a missed fg. L'ville lost B2B games themselves prior to their bye including blowing a 17 pt 4Q lead at home vs UVA. The Cardinals have faced a much tougher sked (#32 vs #123) but BC is 20-7-1 as a dog with 12 outright upsets. We call for the Eagles to pull yet another outright upset, winning here by a fg.

**VIRGINIA TECH by 4 over Syracuse**- Former Big East rivals last met in '16 as ACC foes. The Orange are 4-1 ATS and won the last meeting 31-17 against a ranked VT team. Last Friday we won a 3★ LPS on Syracuse (+13) when the Orange nearly upset Clemson but missed a game tying fg late 4Q. VT only put up 224 yds in a 28-7 (+5) home loss to Pitt last week. QB Burmeister is battling injuries and hit just 11 of 32 passes for 134 yds. Cuse is holding foes 46 ypg below their avg (#42 in FBS) and allow just 114 rush ypg (3.1). VT avg just 312 ypg and puts up 58 ypg less than their foes allow on avg (#121 in FBS). RB Tucker has topped 100 rush yards in 6 of his 7 games including 157 last week vs the Tigers vaunted defense and VT allowed 208 rush yds (4.7) last week. Cuse is used to playing in tight games, having lost 3 straight by a fg in each so we call for another close game.

**PITTSBURGH by 6 over Clemson**- The last time Clemson was an ACC dog was '10 at FSU. LY Clem destroyed a Pitt squad that was depleted on the Oline and couldn't protect Pickett which resulted in 6 sks/5 TO's. We've won B2B LPS going against Clem in each of their L/2 gms where they failed to cover against BC and Cuse! LW the Tigers needed a missed fg late 4Q to avoid OT, only winning 17-14 (-13). Pitt dominated VTech in Blacksburg 28-7 (-5) with RB Abanikanda breaking out with 140 yards. QB Pickett now has a 2-1 ratio and faces Clemson's #16 nk'd pass D. The Tigers avg just 18 ppg and 312 ypg in ACC play while Pitt avg 40 ppg and 496 ypg in 2 ACC games and beat GT by 31 on the road, who Clemson needed a late stop to get past. If Clemson's offense was going to get right, it would have happened out of their bye week vs Cuse so we like Pitt here.

**Maryland by 1 over MINNESOTA** - The Terps lead the matchup 4-2 after LY's huge upset win at home (+20), 45-44 in OT (Minnesota shanked PAT). Maryland won the yd and FD edge (675-471, 28-24) and are 3-1 ATS vs the Golden Gophers S/17 including 2 outright upsets, w/ the Terps outgaining Minnesota by 53 ypg (234 rush ypg). The Gophers have not topped 190 pass yds in the last 3 mtgs and are w/o their top 2 RBs for the ssn. Maryland began the yr 4-0 SU, 3-1 ATS before running into two top-ten tms, but are off a bye while Minnesota is 0-2 ATS as HF TY, including a 14-10 outright upset loss to Bowling Green (-31), who haven't won a gm since. The Terps have had time to pick themselves up, dust themselves off, and we believe they pull another upset in this series and hand yet another outright upset to Minnesota TY on their home turf.

**MICHIGAN by 15 over Northwestern** - Mich has won 6 straight mtgs and 11 of 12. The Wildcats have traded ATS wins and losses in their last 6 mtgs S/11, but this is the highest ranked Wolverine squad they've played in 15 yrs. Northwestern, after being undressed by Nebraska on the road (+11') 56-7, they came back off the bye and got their first SU/ATS Power 5 win against Rutgers at home (+2'), 17-7. Harbaugh is just 3-10 as favorite of 20+ points and NW is 18-6 as away dogs. This is the highest line in this series since '06 when Mich was -29' and only won 17-3. Fitzgerald's teams always improve as the season goes on and Mich has a HUGE game vs Mich St on deck so we think the 'Cats keep this much closer than expected.

**CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 2 over Northern Illinois** - Central Michigan is 6-1 SU/7-0 ATS vs NIU & Huskies have not won in Mt Pleasant since '13. LW NIU (-9') led BG 34-16 in 4Q, but allowed 10 unanswered to only win by 6, their first ATS loss in their L/4 gms. The week after making a come from behind win vs Ohio, CM blew a 23-13 4Q lead vs Toledo & needed OT to win 26-23 as a 5 pt HD, their first cover in their last 5 gms. Two weeks ago NIU led Toledo 19-14 in 4Q & after falling behind 20-19 hit a GW fg with :23 left for a 22-20 win as a 12' pt AD. NIU finished with a 396-371 yd & a 23-15 fd edge while CM were out fd 20-13 & outgained 350-332 by UT. NIU has taken on a tougher schedule (#89-#115) & despite leading the MAC West has opened as a 5 pt AD, that seems a bit much for us & an outright NIU win would not be a shock.

**Kent St by 7 over OHIO** - Ohio has won 6 straight vs Kent St going 4-2 ATS. LW the Flashes suffered their first MAC loss, as after only trailing 23-17 at HT they imploded in 3Q & trailed 50-23 into 4Q & lost 64-31 as a 6' pt AD. They have been outscored 106-16 in 3Q vs FBS foes. LW Ohio (+7') led Buffalo 21-0 into 2Q & 26-10 into 4Q but lost 27-26 on GW fg kicked on an un-timed down after on offsides penalty on a missed fg attempt. They were outgained 373-346. Kent St beat Buffalo 27-20 as a 16' pt HF, despite leading 31-10 at HT as they were outscored 28-3 in 3Q, but still finished with a 633-549 yd edge. Both defenses rank in the bottom 15 of the FBS but Kent St has a huge edge on offense (#20-#119). While Ohio is only avg just 346 ypg, they are avg 202 ypg rush & 5.6 ypc

while KSU is allowing 214 ypg & 5.4 ypc. Kent St should win here but the Bobcats have not lost a MAC game by more than 7 since 2015, so we will not go any higher here.

**Cincinnati by 31 over NAVY** - These teams have met just twice in 65 yrs, w/ the Bearcats 2-0 ATS. In their last matchup in '18, Cincinnati cruised at home (-13') to a 42-0 win w/ +280 yds and a 22-13 FD edge. LW we picked up a 3★ Late Phone Winner as well as our 4th straight Early Bird Comp Winner (Free on Button 9 Mondays, call 1-347-677-1700) after the Bearcats jetted out to a 35-0 lead 2Q at home vs UCF (-21') while holding a 310-29 yd edge w/ 15 FD to the Golden Knights' 1. Cincinnati's offense slowed down in the 2H but the Bearcats held on for a 56-21 win. The Mids were less impressive their last time out, falling on the road to Memphis (+11), allowing several chunk plays including 2 69+ yd TDs and an avg of 27 yds per completion, falling 35-17 (QB Lavatia knocked out of the gm in the 4Q). Cincinnati is 5-0 ATS vs. FBS tms TY and HC Fickell will look for his tm to play a complete gm in this one, so we like the Bearcats by more than 4 td's.

**NCST by 1 over Miami, FL**- NCST is 0-3 SU but is favored against Miami for the first time since before 1981. Last year Miami was a 10 pt favorite but trailed 41-31 4Q before scoring the games last 13 points. Last week the 'Canes put up 42 points, finished +39 yds and +7 FD's but couldn't overcome 3 TO's and lost 45-42 (+7) at NCar. The 'Canes got to the NC16 on their final drive but had a tipped pass int'd. NCST (-3) led 10-7 at half at BC then got a fumble ret td on a dropped punt snap, a 79 yd td pass, BC dropped a td pass which resulted in a missed 32 yd fg and a safety for a misleading score. The 'Pack did finish +102 yds but were -1 FD. QB Leary now has a 16-2 ratio and 'Canes Frosh QB Van Dyke threw 3 picks last week, now facing our #6 ranked pass D. Miami is holding foes 50 ypg below their avg (#29 in FBS) and they've played a much tougher schedule (#37 vs #83) but we like the Wolfpack's edge at QB to make the difference.

**Wake Forest by 7 over ARMY** - Army pulled the upset in the L/mtg in '16, beating WF 21-13 (+6') and also covered in '14, only losing by a fg. WF gets extra prep for the option coming off their bye and they've only got Duke on deck so not likely to look ahead, especially with the Deacons coming in 6-0. Army returns home after B2B road losses to Ball St (28-16) and Wisconsin 20-14. The Black Knights were 2 td dogs and trailed the Badgers 13-0, getting outgained 230-48 in the 1H. Army scored on 2 4Q td drives including their last with :38 left. Army's offense isn't as potent w/o QB Anderson (431 rush, 7.4) who missed L/2 compared to Tyler (109 rush, 2.7). The Deacons have an edge coming off a bye so we like the Deacons but can't go higher than a td.

**USF by 1 over Temple** - The Owls are 5-2 all-time vs USF, including 3 straight wins, but the Bulls are 3-1 ATS S/17. USF proved LW how they've gone just shy of 2 calendar yrs w/o an FBS win, as they hosted Tulsa (+8) and led 31-20 4Q before allg a 99-yd TD drive and the GW TD w/ under a min left, losing 32-31. The Bulls gained just 268 yds while being outgained by 267 and lost the FD edge 13-31. Temple had a bye wk to tend to their wounds from a 52-3 beatdown at the hands of Cincinnati, w/ their lone pts coming off a knuckling 55-yd FG that bounced up and in off the cross-bar. The Owls had won 2 straight headed into that massacre, including an upset win at home over Memphis (+11), 34-31, after erasing a 17-pt deficit by HT. Since we can't ignore this gm's existence, we will take the Bulls at home in a squeaker w/ Temple covering.

**Eastern Michigan by 6 over BOWLING GREEN** - Last met in '17, when Eastern Michigan won 34-31, failing to cover as a 13 pt HF. LW EM never led Ball St & lost 38-31 as a 1 pt HD but were int's in BSU territory with :57 left. After shocking Minnesota 14-10, Bowling Green has dropped 3 straight MAC games. LW BG as a 9 pt AD, trailed NIU 34-16 early 4Q but scored 10 unanswered to only lose 34-26 & with 114 yds on those 2 late drive were only outgained 396-357. EM lost to NIU 27-20 (E) despite finishing with a 376-326 yd edge. Despite being 4-3 SU EM is 2-5 ATS incl 1-2 as a favorite. Falcons are just 2-5 SU but 6-1 ATS incl 6-0 as a dog. However 5 of those are covers are as a dog of 9+ pts (4 by 14+), with their only cover under a td being as a 1' pt dog to FCS foe Murray St. With EM opening as a small favorite, we look for the Eagles to cover here.

**Oklahoma by 45 over KANSAS** - OU has won 16 straight gms vs KU & more recently are 5-2 ATS against KU with all 5 covers coming as at least 25-pt chalk incl LY when OU (-38') took down KU 62-9 (540-246). OU is off a game vs TCU where they won 52-31 (2★ newsletter winner!) while KU is at home for the 2nd straight week & last wk they lost to TTech 41-14 (3★ newsletter winner on TTech). OU's offense looks like it has found its stride with new QB Williams (662 vs Tex, 525 vs TCU) & they have run the ball much better the L/2 gms (339, 8.3 vs Tex / 230, 6.6 vs TCU). OU takes on a KU D that is giving up 529 ypg/49 ppg to FBS foes. OU's R has given up over 500 yds the L/2 gms & have all'd 351 pass ypg the L/3 gms but they face a KU offense that is putting up just 321 ypg/17 ppg. OU is +101 ypg/18 ppg vs B12 foes they take on a KU squad that is -279 ypg/39 ppg against B12 foes & even as heavy chalk we think OU rolls as KU is just 2-11 ATS the L/2Y as a DD dog.

**BALL ST by 3 over Miami, Oh** - Both are 2-1 in MAC play & need a win to keep in their division races. They play for the Red Bird Rivalry Trophy with Miami going 3-1 SU & ATS incl 3-31 win as a 1 pt HF LY, which was Ball St's only MAC loss LY. In that game Miami led 31-21 early 4Q before Ball St tied it 1:08 left but after forcing a punt there an int that set Miami up for a 6 yd td drive w/:25 left. LW Miami as a 20 pt HF led Akron 14-0 into 2Q & 34-7 into 4Q before allowing the final 14 incl a 50 yd td pass w/:31 left. Ball St never trailed but only led EM 17-14 at HT & held on for a 38-31 win as a 1 pt AF finishing with a 433-385 yd edge. The week prior Miami lost to EM 13-12 as a 2 pt AF despite a 385-257 yd edge as they were held to 4 fg's. While Ball St has won 3 in a row SU & ATS, 2 were as a DD dog & one as a 1 pt favorite. Here they have opened as almost a td favorite and that may be a bit too much against a Miami team that is 17-6 in MAC s/18.

Over 39 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years and we picked up our 2nd of the season LW with Purdue upsetting #2 Iowa!! Here is this week's Underdog Play:

## Nevada +4 over FRESNO ST

Nevada by 3 over FRESNO ST - Nev has won 4 of the L/6 gms SU vs Fresno incl winning the L/2 gms both SU/ATS with the home team going 2-8 ATS. Nev QB Strong (1990, 68%, 16-3) takes on Fresno QB Haener (2326, 68%, 20-6) in a battle of the 2 best MW QB's. Fresno is off a 17-0 road win vs WY where they only gained 259 yds (50 yds on 3 scoring drives), but were +5 TO's. Nev is off a 34-17 win against UH and in fact Fresno & Nev have both played UH and while both offenses put up 475+ yds the biggest difference was TO's as Nev was +5 and Fresno was -5! Overall this season Nev is +9 TO's while FSU is -2 TO's. Both teams have solid pass D's (FSU #26, Nev #53) and the Nev pass rush has been on fire the L/3 gms as they have 17 sks! The 'Pack are on a 7-0 ATS run as a dog in reg season gms. We already picked up an Underdog POW outright upset winner back in week 1 with Nevada and will go back to them here!

**WYOMING by 26 over New Mexico** - WY had their 3 gm win streak vs NMex broke LY when the Lobos (+18) went up 17-16 4Q then forced 2 TO's on WY's L/2 drives for their 1st win of the ssn. WY is off a 17-0 home loss to Fresno (-5 TO's) while NMex was held to 79 yds against CSU in a 36-7 loss. NMex has gotten little production from their offense the L/4 gms (197 ypg/9 ppg) and face a WY D that has all'd 280 ypd the L/4 gms & held AF to 211 rush yds (3.3) while NMex gave up 408 rush yds (5.6) to the same AF team. NMex has also all'd 14 sks the L/3 gms & WY's D has collected 11 sks the L/4 gms. WY's offense won't be mistaken for elite but they lean on the run (161, 4.2) and NMex's run D has all'd 258 ypg (4.4) the L/3 gms. After 2 straight gms vs tougher MW foes we think WY will cruise to a win here as long as they take care of the ball as NMex is dealing with an inj to their QB and have yet to cover a game this ssn (0-7 ATS).

**CALIFORNIA by 3 over Colorado** - The Buffs head into Berkeley after reaching the 20 pt plateau for the 1st time TY against an FBS foe in their 34-0 win over the Wildcats (QB Lewis 12-19-248 yds, 2-0 ratio). The Bears meanwhile are off to an 0-3 start in the P12 for a 2nd consecutive year following a 7 pt loss last Friday in Eugene where they actually led in the 4Q (UO 454-402 yd edge). These two have split the L/4 meetings with the home team winning all 4 (2-1-1 ATS). While the Buffs are just 2-6-1 ATS as an AD coming in, it's also worth mentioning that Cal is on a disastrous 0-10-1 as a HF. **Utah by 8 over OREGON ST** - Following a key victory LW in SLC against the Sun Devils where they overcame a 21-7 HT deficit (455-385 yd edge), the Utes find themselves in the driver's seat in the P12 South as they head into Corvallis to take on a well-rested Beavers squad that returns from their bye week (7 pt loss to Wazzou the week prior). While the all-time series is tied at 11-11-1, the Utes have won the L/5 (2-3 ATS) including the L/3 at Reser Stadium (52-7 win '19, -14'). With Utah 6-3 as an AF and the Beavers just 3-10-1 ATS as a HD, we like the visitor to take care of business here.

**BYU by 3 over WASHINGTON ST** - After a narrow 3 pt win over Stanford in Pullman where they got the GW 2-yd TD run w/1:30 left, the Cougars are right back inside of Gesa Field to take on a BYU squad that dropped their 2nd consecutive contest LW in Baylor (Bears 22-15 FD & 534-409 yd edges) following an outstanding 5-0 start that included 3 victories against the P12 (Arizona, Utah & Ariz St). WSU hasn't played a non-conf game after Sept since '09 while BYU has gone 3-1 all-time in this series. With BYU 4-1 ATS on the road dating back to LY, we'll lean in their direction.

**Oregon by 4 over UCLA** - Oregon is off a comeback win on Friday where they got the GW TD w/4:50 left (RB Dye 145 yds & 1 TD) to beat Cal, the Ducks are back on the road for the first time since their surprising OT loss at Stanford as an 8' pt favorite. They face Chip Kelly who spent 4 yrs as UO's HC from '09-'12. The Bruins finished with a 420-267 yd edge in LW's road win against the Huskies. The Ducks have come out victorious in 8 of their L/9 meetings against UCLA (5-4 ATS) including a narrow 38-35 (-17) win a year ago where they turned 4 Bruins TO's into 28 pts. We like Oregon here as they've gone a solid 22-11 ATS as an AF dating all the way back to part of Kelly's tenure in Eugene while the Bruins are on just a 5-10 ATS run as a dog inside of the Rose Bowl.

**Kansas St by 3 over TEXAS TECH** - Since 2011 KSt has gone 9-1 SU/8-2 ATS against TT incl winning & covering the L/4 mtgs. KSt is off a 33-20 home loss to Iowa ST while TT travelled last wk to KU and dominated the Jayhawks 41-14 (3★ newsletter winner). Bkp QB Colombi has come in & the TT offense is still avg'g 447 ypg in his 3 starts & while KSt does a good job stopping the run (86, 2.7) the are giving up 303 pass ypg (73% comp) to B12 foes & they all'd 210 rush yds (6.0) to ISU last wk. However KSt continues on offense with QB Thompson & RB Vaughn & they take on a TT D that has given up over 330 rush yds 2 times to B12 foes TY. QB Thompson can do damage with his arm & TT has already all'd both Tex & WVU to throw for over 300 yds. We like KSt to pull the small road upset (they are the dog as of presstime) as they are 12-6 ATS in the reg ssn as a dog while TT is just 2-5 ATS in their L/7 gms as the favorite.

**IOWA ST by 3 over Oklahoma St** - Since 2012 OSU is 8-1 SU against ISU but have failed to cover 4 of the L/6 gms. ISU is off a 33-20 win at KSt while OSU is on the road for a 2nd straight wk & last wk they trailed 17-13 HY (OSU got a pick-6 mid 2Q) but came back to pull the upset 32-24 (outscored Tex 17-0 4Q). ISU comes in +187 ypg on the ssn as their offense is putting up 87 ypg above what their foes allow on avg. OSU's D is strong (306 ypg/20 ppg all'd) and are holding foes to 142 ypg under their ssn avg (#3 FBS). ISU has ran for 239 ypg (6.7 ypc) the L/3 gms but OSU's run D is all'g just 98 ypg (3.0) and only gave up 138 to Texas LW. OSU's offense has impressed at times (481 yds vs KSt) but overall are avg'g 382 ypg/27 ppg and they face an ISU D is holding tms to 123 ypg under their ssn avg (#6 FBS). These tms have two B12 foes in common (BU/KST) and ISU is +137 ypg/+6 ppg while OSU is +174 ypg/+11 ppg. OSU is 7-1 ATS in their L/8 gms as an AD & the dog is on a 5-1 ATS run in this series. While we think ISU wins outright, we see OSU keeping this game close.

**TEXAS A&M by 27 over South Carolina** - A&M is 7-0 SU and have cov'd 3 straight including LY when the Aggies crushed SC 48-3 and finished w/a 530-150 yd edge. Since getting upset in 2 straight against Ark & Miss St, the Aggies have pulled off an enormous upset over Bama then beat Missouri 35-14 (-11) which gave us a 4★ LPS winner as part of our excellent 5-1 weekend! RB's Spiller and Achane each topped 100 yards. We also won a 4★ Totals play on Saturday in SCar's 21-20 (-18') with the Under (51). The Gamecocks led 14-3 1Q but QB Noland an 8 play/75 yd drive for the GW td with :37 left. A&M is +71 ypg at home and SC is -74 ypg on the road. The Aggies have also ply'd the tougher schedule (#12 vs #62), and still have a shot to win the SEC West if Bama slips up again. SC is 3-6 as an AD while A&M is 14-8 ATS at home so we've got the Aggies winning by nearly 4 td's.

**Mississippi St by 30 over VANDERBILT** - Miss St is 7-1 SU/6-2 ATS in this series but last year they only won 24-17 as 18' pt chalk. The Bulldogs were no match for an angry Bama team last week, losing 49-9 but they did keep it closer for a half, only trailing 21-6. HC Lea is still looking for his first SEC win after the 'Dores lost LW 21-20 as 18' pt dogs at SCar. Vandy trailed 14-3 1Q but did lead 20-14 until they gave up a GW td with :37 left. Vandy was w/o QB Seals so bkp Mike Wright made his first career start (11-21-206-1-1). Miss St QB Rogers threw 3 int's LW but should have a bounce back performance against our #109 ranked pass D. Miss St is +52 ypg despite ply'g the #2 toughest schedule while Vandy is -139 ypg against the #35 toughest schedule. We like the Bulldogs to win easily and Vandy is 3-14 as a home dog.

## REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK..... WYOMING SERIES PLAY OF THE WEEK..... SAN DIEGO ST TECHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK..... LIBERTY

**Wisconsin by 4 over PURDUE** - The Badgers have won 14 straight contests dating back to '04. We used Purdue as our Underdog Play of the Week vs. #2 Iowa on the road (+11'), and it not only cashed but won outright, 24-7. WR Bell was spectacular (240, 21.8) as was QB O'Connell (375, 75%, 2/0). Wisconsin QB Mertz however continues to turn in pedestrian performances (893, 56%, 2/7 in 6 gms), a real shame considering the immaculate play of the Badger defense as they allow 176 yds less than their opponents produce on avg (#2 in FBS). We think this is a very close gm but that Wisconsin catches Purdue napping off a monumental upset and wins by just over a FG.

**MISSISSIPPI by 7 over Lsu** - Ole Miss is out for revenge after LY's 53-48 (-1') road loss. In fact, HC Orgeron has won all 5 series meetings (4-1 ATS). The Rebels beat Tennessee 31-26 (-2) last week despite a hostile crowd and missing 4 offensive starters and both of their top 2 WR's by the end of the game. Matt Corral might need some rest after rushing for 195 yards on 30 carries and could barely pick himself up off the turf by game's end. LSU has battled injuries of their own, with their top 3 players likely OFY, yet the Tigers managed to pull the upset over Florida 49-42 (+12'). RB Tyrion Davis-Price had 288 rush in 6 games entering LW then ran for 287 against Florida. Ed Orgeron is on his way out but his team obviously hasn't quit and we can't go with Ole Miss is tired and beat up after last week so we will take the Tigers to keep it closer than expected.

**South Alabama by 20 over ULM** - These tms have split the L/4 mtgs SU but SAAla has covered 3 of those 4 gms. ULM is off a shocking upset (+33) vs Liberty, winning 31-28 (3★ LP winner on Over 57') while SAAla played last Thur vs GStirn & won 41-14 (545-233). SAAla faced the #127 pass D last wk & threw for 405 yds & now they face ULM who has the #124 pass D. SAAla also has a solid rush attack (168, 4.2 the L/4 gms) and ULM's rush D has given up 284 rush ypg (5.7) the L/3 gms. Despite ULM winning 3 gms this ssn they have been outgained in every gm but in their 3 wins they are +5 TO's. SAAla's D has been playing well this ssn as they are all'g 298 ypg/19 ppg and are holding foes to 45 ypg under their ssn avg. ULM is a scrappy team (3 wins) but they are -196 ypg on the season & SAAla has a stellar D and are off their most impressive win with a couple extra days of rest.

**Liberty by 31 over NORTH TEXAS** - Only prior meeting was in '18 when NT beat Liberty 47-7 (-12) but that was before QB Willis and HC Freeze. Lib suffered the largest upset of this season last week when the Flames went down 31-29 vs ULM. We did pick up a 3★ win on the Over (59) as part of our 3-1 LP Totals day (10-4 on LP Totals L3W!!!). Apologies for the double-Marquee loss on Friday Night that North Texas was a part of. The Mean Green trailed 42-7 at home at half in a loss that ultimately be the final straw for HC Littrell. NT has lost 5 straight with 3 coming by 22 pts or more. Lib already has 3 wins over CUSA foes by 27 ppg including a 36-12 win over UAB (+219 yds). NT lost to that same UAB squad 40-6 (-187 yds). Despite LW's loss, Lib is still on a 13-2 ATS run which includes 5 straight covers over CUSA foes. Freeze is 7-2 ATS off a loss while NT is on a 9-25 ATS run.

**LOUISIANA TECH by 3 over Utsa** - Utsa is 7-0 and are 1 win short of tying the school's single ssn mark. The Roadrunners broke a 6 game series losing streak LY, winning 27-26 (+2') but they did trail 19-6 at half. We're not sure what the heck happened to LA Tech LW in their 19-3 (-6') loss to UTEP which cost us both a 3★ on these pages and our 4★ top LPS (only play that lost!). The Bulldogs struggled against a talented Miners' Dline which resulted in 4 sacks and QB Kendall threw 3 int's. They should have more success throwing against a UTSA secondary which allowed 300+ pass yds in 3 straight before LW's 36 yds allowed against a stagnant Rice pass game. UTSA won 45-0 over Rice but 4 of their wins have come by 7 pts or less and we don't mind playing against a team who is ranked for the first time ever! Holtz is 21-8-2 as a dog with 13 outright upsets and we already won an underdog POW using the Bulldogs when they covered (and lost on a hail mary) against SMU.

**Wku by 24 over FIU** - WKU has won 6 of the L/8 mtgs and are 6-3 ATS in this series with 2 straight wins both SU & ATS. The 'Toppers were desperate for a win LW and jumped on ODU 30-3 at half, eventually winning 43-20 (-13'). QB Zappe now has a 26-4 ratio and his top target and fellow Hou Bapt transfer Jerreth Sterns has gone for 186, 195 and 212 and has 962 in just 6 games! FIU is fresh off a bye after losing to Charlotte 45-33 the Thurs prior. The Panthers are #125 in our pass D rankings, giving up 67% and 295 pass ypg and their 17-1 ratio allowed has to be giving WKU QB Zappe some happy dreams. The 'Toppers are 2-4 but their next 3 games are winnable and could lead to a showdown with FAU. We will call for a dominant win by more than 3 td's for WKU.

**San Diego St by 3 over AIR FORCE** - SDSt has won 10 straight gms SU against AF and they are 8-2 ATS in those gms however their last mtg came back in '18. SDSt has done well vs the AF option in the past as they have held AF to 220 rush yds or less in 5 of the L/7 gms incl holding them to under 200 rush yds in 3 gms. SDSt's strong rush D is all'g just 61 ypg (2.1) but AF is rushing for 343 ypg (5.0) the L/4 gms. The issue at times for SDSt has been their offense TY as they are only avg'g 349 ypg and LW vs SJSJ they gained just 240 ttl yds (50 yds came in 2 OT's). The AF D is only giving up 289 ypg/16 ppg & are holding foes to 83 ypg under their ssn avg. **NOTRE DAME by 14 over Usc** - This series was interrupted for the first time ever a year ago due to Covid (rivalry started in 1926!). Both teams are fresh off byes with the Trojans being hammered by the Utes at home prior to their week off and the Irish escaping with a 32-29 victory at Virginia Tech. After winning 7 straight in this series from '02-'09, USC has now dropped 2 of the L/10 vs the Irish including LTH ('19) where they battled back from 17 down in the eventual 30-27 defeat. With the Trojans on just a 3-9 ATS run we don't mind backing the Irish here.

**HAWAII by 10 over New Mexico St** - Second meeting of the ssn. These teams met a month ago at NMSt and UH (-17) only led 17-13 at HT but outscored NMSt in the 2H 24-7 to leave with a 41-21 win. NMSt is off a bye week so the trip to the islands won't be as taxing of a trip. UH is off a 34-17 road loss to Nevada as they were only outgained by 84 yds but were -5 TO's. NMSt's D has struggled at times this ssn, as they are all'g 464 ypg/42 ppg the L/4 gms and UH's offense has put up 401 ypg/25 ppg the L/4 gms & QB Corderio could be back for this gm (missed L/2 gm w/ inj). UH's pass D for the ssn is all'g 307 ypg (do have 8 int's) and they face a NMSt pass attack that has avg'd 332 ypg the L/4 gms. With these team playing only a month ago, they are familiar with each other & this gm should be closer this time around. UH is also just 5-15-1 ATS s/16 as home chalk.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ NEW ENGLAND over NY Jets** - Following an OT loss to the Cowboys where they had large FD (32-17) and yard (567-335) deficits, the Patriots are back in Foxboro for a 4th time in 5 weeks to take on a rested Jets squad that has gone just 4-8 ATS after a bye. In their earlier meeting back in Wk 2, the Patriots (-6) took advantage of four Zach Wilson int's in the 25-6 road victory (3★ LP Winner!). With the Patriots a solid 10-4 ATS as a DIV HF coming in and the Jets failing to cover 15 of their L/20 against the AFC East, we have no issue giving the home squad a 2 TD lean in this one (NYJ 2-8 ATS as an AD).

**FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 14**

**3★ Carolina over NY GIANTS** - Following an OT loss at home to the Vikings for their 3rd consecutive defeat after an impressive 3-0 start, the Panthers head North to take on a Giants squad that suffered a 27 pt beatdown at home against the Rams with RB Saquon Barkley and WR Kenny Golladay out with injury (LAR 365-261 yd edge). The Panthers have come out victorious in each of their past 3 matchups against the Giants including a 33-31 home win back in '18 (GW 63-yd FG w/:01 left!). While they are 3-10-1 ATS as an AF coming in, also keep in mind that the Giants have failed to cover 16 of their L/20 as a HD.

**FORECAST: Carolina by 10**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Atlanta over MIAMI** - This is an unusual spot for the Dolphins as they return home from London (JAX GW 53-yd FG as time expired to end their 20-gm losing skid!) having to play a game instead of heading to their bye week. The Falcons meanwhile are off a bye following their own trip across the pond where they knocked off the Jets. In their most recent matchup in '17, the Falcons (-13) suffered a surprising home upset against the Dolphins who overcame a 17-0 HT deficit to pick up the 20-17 victory (ATL 339-289 yd edge). While the Falcons had covered just 1 of 12 non-conf matchups from '17-'19, they've flipped that record over the past 2 years with a solid 4-1 ATS mark. The extra rest should pay off for the visitor in this one!

## OTHER PLAYS

**Denver at CLEVELAND - Thursday** - Following their 3rd consecutive loss LW at home against the Raiders where they had a 4-0 TO deficit in the 10 pt defeat (3★ Newsletter Winner on LV!), the Broncos head to CLE to take on a Browns squad that suffered a 37-14 home loss to the Cardinals where we picked up a 4★ Newsletter Winner. Dating back to the '91 season, the Broncos have knocked off the Browns on 12 of the past 13 occasions including a 24-19 victory in '19 (CLE 21-13 FD & 351-302 yd edges). While DEN has also picked up covers in 5 of their L/6 as a NDIV AD, they are heading East for a 2nd time in 3 weeks and on short rest to boot. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**BALTIMORE by 10 over Cincinnati** - The Ravens are back at home for a 3rd straight week following a comeback win on MNF against the Colts and blowout of the Chargers where they finished 27-14 FD and 327-208 yd edges. The Bengals meanwhile are in the midst of a 3-game road trip that saw them pick up a 34-11 win LW in DET (QB Burrow 271 pass yds & 3 TD's). The Ravens have picked up 5 consecutive wins over the Bengals (3-2 ATS) including a pair of blowouts LY where they outscored CIN by a combined 65-6 margin. With BAL also posting a solid 10-3 overall ATS run and the Bengals failing to cover 9 of their L/14 coming in, the home team gets the DD edge here.

**GREEN BAY by 13 over Washington** - This marks the only HG in a 5-week span for the Packers (at ARZ & KC on deck) who picked up their 5th straight win LW in Soldier Field against the Bears (3★ LP Winner!). WAS meanwhile was held scoreless in the 2H of a 31-13 home defeat to the Chiefs (WAS led 13-10 at HT). In their Lambeau Field meeting in '19, the Packers (-13) squeaked out a narrow 20-15 victory with a 341-262 yard edge. With GB also a solid 12-6 ATS as a HF and WAS still attempting to fix a defense that finished #2 in the NFL at 305 ypg (#31 TY allowing 423 ypg!), we're expecting them to drop their 5th game in 6 tries ATS in this one.

**Kansas City by 1 over TENNESSEE** - The Titans are back in Nashville for a 2nd straight week following a MNF matchup against the Bills. The Chiefs meanwhile got back to .500 on the year with an 18 pt win over WAS where they had 29-15 FD and 499-276 yd edges. In their playoff meeting of '19, the Chiefs would finish with 27-20 FD and 404-295 yard edges in the 35-24 Arrowhead victory. The Chiefs have however covered just 2 of their L/14 coming in (and trailed 13-10 at HT LW vs WAS) which doesn't bode well against a TEN squad that's been a solid 6-2 ATS when being listed as a NDIV HD.

**LA RAMS by 7 over Detroit** - Jared Goff and Matt Stafford take on their former squads as the Lions travel to LA! The Lions are still winless on the season following a 23 pt home defeat against the Bengals where they were held to just 228 yds. The Rams meanwhile picked up a dominant 27 pt road win against the Giants with Stafford throwing for 251 yds and 4 TD's. In their most recent meeting back in '18, the Rams (-10) picked up a 30-16 road victory (344-310 yd edge). While the Rams are also a solid 6-3 ATS as a NDIV HF, they do have their 3rd road trip in 4 weeks on deck. We're keeping our lean at just a TD as the Lions have covered 3 of 4 when getting 7+ points so far this season including a pair of 2 pt heartbreaking defeats against the Ravens and Vikings.

**LAS VEGAS by 6 over Philadelphia** - Rematch of SB XV where the Raiders picked up a relatively easy 27-10 victory. The Raiders picked up a big road win LW in DEN in their first game without Jon Gruden as we cashed an easy 3★ Newsletter Winner. The Eagles meanwhile head out West with extra rest after a loss on Thur night against TB where they were held to just 213 yds. The Eagles have won their last 2 matchups against the Raiders including a 19-10 home win back in '17 where they benefitted from +3 TO's (PHI outgained 274-216). While the Raiders have failed to cover 4 of their L/5 as a NDIV HF, the Eagles are on just a 3-6 ATS run coming in and could struggle here.

HOU meanwhile had no answer for the Colts a week ago in a 31-3 road defeat. The all-time series between HOU and ARZ has been split at 2 apiece with the Texans picking up the most recent matchup back in '17 (31-21, -2). While ARZ has gone just 3-8 ATS as a HF coming in, we're backing them here as HOU has failed to cover 10 of their L/14 matchups against the NFC (rookie QB Mills 0-6 ratio in F/2 road starts).

**Indianapolis at SAN FRANCISCO - SNF** - Following a 28 pt home win over the Texans where RB Jonathan Taylor had another big outing rushing for 145 yds and 2 TD's, the Colts head out West to take on a 49ers squad that returns from their bye week with a handful of questions at the QB position (Jimmy Garoppolo & Trey Lance ? with inj's). The Colts have picked up 4 consecutive victories in this series (3-1 ATS) including a 26-23 OT win back in '17. They have also gone 11-3-1 ATS vs NFC foes. While SF has struggled as a HF recently failing to cover 9 straight, they have gone 11-5 ATS in their recent non-conf matchups. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

**New Orleans at SEATTLE - MNF** - The Seahawks return to the Pacific NW following a SNF battle in PIT where they dropped a 23-20 contest in OT (bcp QB Geno Smith 23-32-209-1-0, fumble in OT). The Saints meanwhile are well-rested after a bye week and boasting a 10-3-1 ATS run coming in. In their most recent meeting back in '19, the Saints (+4) were without the services of QB Drew Brees but still picked up the 33-27 win with Teddy Bridgewater throwing for 177 yards and 2 TD's. While Russell Wilson won't be starting a game under center at home for the 1st time in 10+ years, the Seahawks have gone 10-4 ATS as a HD coming in.
