## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Notre Dame over VIRGINIA TECH** - This is Notre Dame's 1st trip to Blacksburg and just their 2nd meeting ever (34-31 VT win in '16). One week after VT was shocked by Old Dominion as 4 td chalk, the Hokies bounced back with an upset win of their own, beating Duke 31-14 (+3). Making his first start since QB Jackson's inj, QB Willis threw for 332 and 3 td's. Last week we used Notre Dame as a 4★ LPS (upgraded from 3★ on these pages) and the Irish gave us an easy winner by beating Stanford 38-17 (-5). QB Book threw for 278 and 4 td's. ND put up 555 yds incl 161 rush from RB Dexter Williams who ply'd his first gm this year (susp). The Hokies are +92 ypg but this is a young defense that is #107 in the FBS, allowing 49 ypg more than their foes avg. ND's OFF is #24, avg 86 ypg more than their foes allow. ND's D has also held Mich, Stanf & WF to their lowest OFF output of the ssn. VT has pulled 2 outright upsets but we will take the Irish by DD's.

**FORECAST: Notre Dame by 14**

**3★ FLORIDA (+) over LSU** - This game is in 'The Swamp' for the 2nd straight ssn after losing last year thanks to a missed PAT, 17-16 (-1). Five of the last 8 mtgs have resulted in outright upsets. Since 1979, the Gators have only been a home dog once vs LSU, and that resulted in a 14-6 Florida (+3) win in 2012. Florida is off a 13-6 win in HC Mullen's 1st trip back to Starkville. The Gators held a 226-43 yd edge at halftime and won 13-6 (+7). Joe Burrow had his best performance of the ssn vs Ole Miss last week, throwing for 292 & 3 td's and rushing for 96 (10.7). LSU is +63 ypg and their D is #16, allowing 108 ypg less than what their foes avg. Florida is +67 ypg and their D is #29, allowing 89 ypg less than what their foes avg. QB Burrow will face a tough test against UF's pass D who has allowed 41% compl the L2 games. Florida was 0-5 as a dog last year but HC Mullen is much better in this role and don't forget he was 4-0 ATS with 2 outright upsets vs LSU while at Miss St.

**FORECAST: FLORIDA by 3**

**3★ Buffalo over CENTRAL MICHIGAN** - CM is 7-1 SU (5-3 ATS) vs UB including 5 str wins but they have not met since the LTH, a 51-14 CM win (-6) in '15. While CM is just 1-4 SU they are 4-1 ATS including 3 straight covers but are off a physical 31-20 loss at Mich St and their only win was 17-5 (-5) over FCS Maine. The Bulls started the ssn 4-0 SU (3-1 ATS) including a 42-13 blowout of Rutgers as a 6' pt AF. Off that huge win the Bulls were brought back to reality LW as they were upset by a solid Army team that took Oklahoma to OT the week prior. The Bulls are led by QB Jackson, who is avg 241 ypg (59%) with an outstanding 16-3 ratio and should get back here.

**FORECAST: Buffalo by 12**

**2★ COLORADO over Arizona St** - Following a successful Friday Night victory over the Bruins that saw them move to 10-3 at home over the past 3 years (26-15 FD, 477-289 yd edges), the Buffs are back in Boulder to take on a Sun Devils squad that they've dropped 8 of the past 9 against including an 11 pt loss in the desert a ssn ago (ASU 583-454 yd edge, Colorado actually led 27-17 in 3Q). The Sun Devils were able to end their 2-gm skid a week ago in Tempe against the Beavers as RB Benjamin ran for a school-record 312 yds and 4 TD's in the easy 28 pt victory. However, ASU has been a different team away from home over the past 4 years with a 4-13 combined SU mark that includes an 0-2 start to '18 with losses to SDSt and Wash.

**FORECAST: COLORADO by 8**

**2★ UNLV over New Mexico** - This series is almost dead even, with UNLV holding a 12-11 advantage. Last ssn's game was tight (no tm led by more than 10 pts) and the lead changed 4 times in the final 10 minutes with UNLV getting a TD with 25 sec left to win 38-35. In last ssn's meeting UNLV held NM to ZERO yds passing, but all'd 482 rush yds. NM is on a 3-8 run ATS and is off a 52-43 loss at home to Liberty, while UNLV is coming off a bye and gets this game at home. NM is all'g 260 rush ypg, while spells trouble for the Lobos as UNLV's run game is rated among the top 5 in all of the FBS with 337 rush ypg and both QB Armani Rogers and RB Lexington Thomas are among the top 25 rushing leaders in the FBS. NM was dealt a devastating blow when starting QB Tevaka Tuiofi broke his collarbone last week and will miss the rest of the ssn. Since 2008 UNLV is 6-2 SU and ATS in the series. Losing their top tk'r for the ssn as well as their top QB will be a tough blow for the Lobos and we like UNLV to win this one by over a couple TD's at home.

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY October 4TH:

**Tulsa vs HOUSTON** - Tulsa is on a 6-2 ATS series run & won LY by 4 td's despite being nearly a 2 td dog due to 2 td drives of under 10 yds & a fumble return td! Both schools enter fresh off a bye. This will be TU's 2nd straight Thursday game. The Hurricane is allowing 215 (4.9) rush ypg vs FBS foes & UH is avg 253 (6.4) rush ypg with a 3 headed RB attack led by Patrick Carr (201, 6.3). Kendall Briles uptempo offense has led to the Cougars defense being suprisingly shredded, allowing 558 ypg & 36 ppg vs FBS foes! TU is 13-5 as an AD, but UH is 9-5 ATS off a bye.

**Georgia St vs TROY** - Last ssn Troy entered the GSt game off an SBC loss to SAIA and got out to a 21-3 lead at HT and wound up winning 34-10 w/ a 457-307 yd edge. After losing week 1 to Boise at home, Troy has rebounded nicely with 4 straight wins, incl a win on the road against Nebraska. Georgia St on the other hand was struggling going into last weeks game vs ULM, but ran for a school record 308 yds and scored 46 pts on the Warhawks and are 1-0 in SBC play. GSt's defense is still a question as they are surrendering 33.6 ppg and 478 ypg. Troy QB Kaleb Barker has started out the ssn well throwing for 877 yds with an 8-2 ratio. Barker, along with Troy's running attack (282 rush yds LW vs Coastal, 196 rush ypg this ssn) should put up another strong performance in this one. This is the 6th straight ssn these 2 teams have met and Troy leads this series 4-1 SU (2-3 ATS). Georgia St is 19-6 as an away dog the last 5 years, but Troy is still among the best of the best in the SBC.

### FRIDAY October 5TH:

**MARSHALL by 8 over Middle Tennessee** - The winner of this game has a big leg up in the CUSA East standings after winning tight games last week. We called for MT to pull the upset over FAU as our Underdog POW on these pages a week ago, and they did exactly that, rallying from a 24-10 3Q deficit, scoring their last td w/38 left and adding a go-ahead 2 pt conv. The Blue Raiders got 3 starters back from inj vs FAU, incl RB Thomas who scored their last td. Marshall overcame 4 TO's to beat WKU 20-17 (-3). The Herd drove 98/7pl for the go-ahead score. QB Green was inj'd on the his 32 yd gm deciding td pass (CS). MT is -64 ypg while MU is +20. Marshall has our #38 pass eff D while MT is only #110. The Herd also have been much better defending the run (103 ypg, 2.9) while MT has struggled (203, 4.9). Marshall has failed to cover their L/5 at home but MT is 1-6 ATS on the road and we feel the Herd have a big edge on D.

**Georgia Tech by 10 over LOUISVILLE** - This is UL's first game ever vs GT's triple option and playing on a Friday night, they get 1 less day to prepare for it. Georgia Tech has dominated their rotational cross-division games to the tune of a 14-1 SU/9-5-1 ATS record. We used the Jackets as our 4★ POW on these pages last week and GT shredded BG 63-17 (-28). Lville looked like they might finally get a win, up 24-21 inside the FSU21 w/under 2 minutes left, QB Pass threw an int and UL all'd a 58 yd td pass. The Cards finished with +51 yd & +8 FD, and their OFF put up a ssn high 421 yds. GT is #54 on OFF, avg 42 ypg more than their foes allow while UL is #116, avg 66 ypg less than what their foes give up. Last week the Jackets ran all over a team that wasn't used to dealing with the option and we expect a similar performance here.

**Utah St by 3 over BYU** - These teams have split their last 4 meetings, but last year Utah St came back from a 21-7 deficit to roll BYU at home 40-24 thanks in large part to the Aggies being +6 in TO's against the Cougars. BYU is 13-3 SU in the series the last 21 years, but Utah St is off a bye and BYU is playing a sixth straight week and just played a physical game at Washington where they lost 35-7 and were outgained 464-194 as well as out FD'd 26-7. BYU will be playing on a short week. Since 1978 Utah St is 1-18 SU at BYU but that win was in 2014 (35-20) when Utah St was just as experienced as they are this ssn. Utah St has been impressive, avg'g 475 ypg and 51.5 ppg, while the BYU defense is giving up just 355 yds and 21 ppg. Utah St is on a 7-3 ATS run in this series & 4-1 ATS in Provo. With an extra week to prepare we will lean with the Aggies in this one.

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## SATURDAY October 6TH:

**GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 17 over South Alabama** - GS has owned this series, winning all 4 gms by nearly 32 ppg. Last ssn at home, the Eagles outgained SAIA 583-196 and held the Jaguars to just 29 rush yds while collecting 356 rush yds of their own in a 52-0 rout. Last week GS won at home vs Ark St 28-21 despite being outgained 493-409 and out FD'd 28-15. Meanwhile SAIA got throttled 52-7 at App St as they were outgained 517-308 and all'd 348 rush yds. This is the 3rd straight road gm for SAIA and their 4th in 5 games, while GS is at home for the 2nd straight week and will surely go right at the suspect SAIA run defense with their option attack. SAIA finally have a QB who can lead this offense in Evan Orth, but it's the Jagu-ars are just 3-9 ATS as a road dog in SBC play s/2014 and we will side with the home favorite in this game.

**USF by 14 over MASSACHUSETTS** - First meeting. USF enters fresh off a much needed bye & this is their 1st true road game. Following B2B double-digit 4Q come-from-behind wins, the Bulls were tested at home vs EC, finishing with season lows in FD's (9) & yards (296). Umass QB Andrew Ford was a ? going into LW, but he appeared fine, throwing for 355 (71%, 4-1) at Ohio. The Minutemen led 21-7 late 1Q, but were then outscored 51-21 as they allowed season highs in total (664) & rush 394 (9.0) yards. USF had B2B 215+ rush yards vs GT & IL & RB Jordan Cronkrite should have no trouble attaining his 3rd straight 100+ yard performance. USF is 11-21 as an AF and 6-11 ATS off a bye. UMass has proven capable to put points on the board so backdoor potential exists.

**Clemson by 17 over WAKE FOREST** - Clemson nearly had their ssn derailed vs Syracuse last week. In their first game since Kelly Bryant left the team, QB Lawrence was inj'd 2Q (CS) and Clemson found themselves down 23-13 3Q. The Tigers held the Orange to 90 yds in the 2H and rFR QB Chase Brice led a 94/13pl drive. RB Etienne put the team on his back with 203 (7.5) and 3 td's. CU finished with +158 yd & +15 FD edges. WF fired their DC, Jay Sawvel, after giving up 1,090 yds and 97 pts in losses to BC and ND. Against Rice, WF all'd 370 yds and 24 pts, but also recorded 2 defensive td's in a 32 pts win (-27). WR Dortch tied his own school rec with 4 td catches (11-163). The Tigers have failed to cover the L/4, though they did lead 28-0 LY before WF added 2 late td's. WF is 10-4-1 as a dog since 2016 and with Clemson's QB issues, we will call for the Deacons to stay within 20 pts.

**TEMPLE by 9 over East Carolina** - Temple has won & covered all 4 meetings as AAC rivals by an avg score of 29-11. The Owls had a season high 523 yards LY. Both enter off emotional games. Temple gained a season high 452 yards, but allowed the game-deciding td w/3:11 left 4Q at BC. RB Ryquell Armstead finished w/a season high 171 (7.1) rush yards, his 3rd straight game w/100+. Despite finishing with a 492-271 yard edge, EC needed 2 scores in the 4Q including the GW 38 yd fg w/46 left in their come-from-behind win vs Old Dominion. After having among the worst defenses the L2Y, the Pirates have shown a ton of growth under new DC David Blackwell. EC has held their L/2 foes to season lows in yards & are holding their opponents to 116 ypg under their season avg!

**Northern Illinois by 6 over BALL ST** - LY NIU covered as a 31' pt HF winning 63-17 with 2 blk'd punt td's. LTH NIU only won 31-24 but that was as a 4 pt AD. Ball St is off an impressive 52-24 win over KSU as a 7 pt HF. NIU is off a 3 OT 26-23 win over EM as a 3 pt AD. They struggled on offense scoring half their points in OT but held EM to a ssn low 13 in regulation. That is as you would expect as Ball St has the offensive edge (#33-#129) but NIU has the defensive edge (#62-#117). NIU has won 9 straight over Ball St going 7-2 ATS including 6 straight covers and we will call for that trend to continue here.

**Syracuse by 7 over PITTSBURGH** - The Panthers are 13-3 SU/11-5 ATS in this series. The LTH these two combined for the highest scoring game in FBS history w/137 points and 1,312 yards. Last year it was much lower scoring with Cuse winning 27-20 and Pitt lost their starting QB in the 3Q. Cuse is off an emotional 27-23 (+25) loss to Clemson where they led 23-13 3Q and all'd a gm deciding 94/13pl td drive. The Orange were actually outgained by 158 yds (28-12 FD deficit) despite Clemson losing QB Lawrence in the 2Q. Pitt is off a 45-14 (+13) beatdown at UCF where they were outgained 568-272. Pitt is -87 ypg and are giving up 201 (5.0) rush ypg despite their entire front 7 from last year being back. Cuse is +78 ypg and their OFF is #25, avg 85 ypg more than their foes allow. Cuse has covered all 5 this year so we will take the Orange by a td.

**UCF by 25 over Smu** - UCF is 7-1 SU in the series & the home team has covered 6 straight. The Sonny Dykes era didn't start off smoothly for SMU, but they enter off B2B wins after following up their outright upset over Navy with an easy win over FCS Houston Baptist. True frosh QB William Brown replaced Ben Hicks as the starter vs Navy & threw for 309 (60%, 2-1) LW. Hicks remains in the QB rotation, however. UCF enters off their best performance of the season. Eager to show voters what they're capable of vs P5 foes, the Knights led Pitt 31-7 at HT, finished w/568 total yards & held Pitt to a season low 272 yards! SMU ranks just #116 in our PDR, while UCF QB McKenzie Milton remains 1 of the best signalcallers in the game. SMU lost to Michi-gan by 25 & lost to TCU by 20. UCF has no more games vs P5 foes, so what other way to get voters attention than to blow out a team that has played P5 foes. UCF is 7-3 as a HF, but we'll agree with the linesmakers.

**FAU by 10 over Old Dominion** - Last year ODU was dealing with multiple injuries and FAU (-5) ran for 453 yds (6.6) in the Owls 30 pt win. The visitor has won all 4 in this series (3-1 ATS). We went against FAU (-3) for our Underdog POW last week and picked up our 2nd consec outright winner. FAU led 24-10 3Q before allowing MT to get 2 td's incl with :38 left then added a 2 pt conv. ODU was off their stunning upset of VT and nearly pulled another in their 37-35 (+7) loss at EC. The Monarchs led 35-34 but allowed a gm winning fg w/46 left. ODU was outgained by 221 yds and had td drives of 5, 39 & 49 yds. ODU is -121 ypg and allows 119 (4.9) rush ypg which is slightly worse than LY. FAU avg 231 (4.9) rush ypg which is a far cry from LY's 285 (6.0) but they've also rushed for 323 (5.8) in their L/3. The Owls are 0-5 ATS this year and ODU has covered B2B as dogs.

**OHIO ST by 21 over Indiana** - IU was on a 6-0 ATS series run before losing by 4 td's at home in LY's opener. OSU enters off an emotional come-from-behind win at PSU where they trailed by double-digits in the 4Q & rallied to score 2 td's including the GW 24 yd td pass w/2:03 left. The Buckeyes were susceptible to QB scrambles & while IU QB Peyton Ramsey has proven to be mobile, he's nowhere near as quick as Trace McSorley. IU was in complete control LW, leading Rutgers 24-7 at the half w/a 292-134 yard edge, but a conservative 2H approach along with an inability to establish a run game nearly cost them & they won by only a td. OSU has seen their rush ypg decrease each of their L/4 games, but that trend will end here vs a Hoosier defense that allowed FIU, UVA & Ball St to avg 187 (4.8) rush ypg. Indy tends to play OSU tough & we feel will do so again.

**Boston College by 10 over NC STATE** - The visitor has won the L/4 in this series (3-1 ATS) incl LY when BC QB Brown was inj'd 1Q and NC St went on to win 17-14 (-3). Last week BC trailed Temple 21-13 before scoring 18 unanswered and led 31-21 at half despite being out'd by 26 yds. BC only led 38-35 until a late td. RB Dillon went for 161 but was inj'd 3Q (CS) and replaced by bkp Ben Glines who ran for a career high 120 (5.2). NCSt is off a 35-21 (-6) win that saw the Wolfpack put up the most yds UVA has all'd this ssn w/433. NCSt's D allowed just 351 yds and 75 yds of that came on a td drive in gbg time. The Wolfpack's inexperienced DL will be severely tested vs BC who brought all 5 OL starters back from LY along with Dillon and rushes for 249 (4.9) ypg. BC is 10-2 as an AD and is on a 13-2 overall ATS run. Assuming Dillon is healthy, we will call for the upset.

**Missouri by 3 over SOUTH CAROLINA** - The road team has won 3 of the last 5 including last year when SC won by 18 pts despite being outgained by 64 yds (SC +3 TO's, 97 yd KR). The dog has also pulled 3 outright upsets in the L/5. MO enters well rested off a bye while SC dropped to 1-2 in SEC play after a 24-10 (E) loss at KY. SC was outgained 252-117 and trailed 24-3 at the half. QB Bentley threw 3 int's and was inj'd in the 4Q (CS). The Tigers OFF has put up the most yards that each of their 3 FBS foes have allowed (#1 in nation, +206 ypg more than foes have allowed). SC is 7-3 ATS vs SEC foes but MO is on a 10-2 ATS run incl 4-2 ATS on the road. QB Lock has struggled vs bowl foes and SC's D is #8, allowing 121 ypg less than what their foes avg. This game features 2 of the lowest rated pass D's in the SEC (MO #101, SC #81) so there could be plenty of points. MO is 4-1 as a dog and we will call for QB Lock to lead the upset.

**MICHIGAN by 21 over Maryland** - After losing the 1st meeting as B10 rivals, UM has won 3 in a row SU/ATS by a combined score of 122-13. MD enters fresh off a bye after rebounding from their lone loss to Temple with a dominant win over MN. UM has Wisconsin on deck & enters off an emotional come-from-behind win at NW. Trailing 17-0 early 2Q, the Wolve's limited NW to 97 total yards in the L3Q, scored the GW td w/4:06 remaining & finished w/a 376-202 yard edge. UM has held 4 of their 5 foes to season lows in yards & leads the FBS holding opponents to 234 ypg below their avg. Under the guidance of new OC/interim HC Matt Canada, MD has finished with the most yards allowed by 3 of their 4 opponents. The Terps are 7-13 as a DD dog & hasn't been able to match-up physically with the Wolve's recently. We'll call for UM to give their homecoming crowd something to cheer about with a win by 3 td's.

**CINCINNATI by 9 over Tulane** - Cincy has won & covered both meetings as AAC rivals. The Bearcats finished w/a season high 456 yards in LY's 1 point win, which saw TU miss the potential GW 36 yard fg w/1:21 left. It's homecoming weekend in Cincy and the Bearcats have left the city just once in the L5 weeks and has a bye on deck. While Cincy hasn't defended the option yet, they did limit TU to just 132 (3.8) rush yards LY and return 3 DL & 2 LB starters. TU enters off their best game of the season, dominating Memphis by over 2 td's & finishing w/a 496-277 yard edge! While the Green Wave enter with an extra days rest, they are travelling for the 3rd time in 4 weeks. Cincy's offense is more balanced with QB Desmond Ridder under center.

**Ohio by 7 over KENT ST** - Ohio has won 4 straight SU & ATS in the series but only led 13-3 (-18) at HT LY before outscoring KSU 35-0 in the 2H. This is a different KS offense under new HC Lewis, as after scoring just 12.8 ppg LY they have put up 25.8 ppg TY. However they were blown out 52-24 LW by Ball St as a 7' pt AD. They are led by former Auburn signee QB Woody Barrett, who is avg 238 ypg (60%, 5-5) and is the #2 rusher with 161 yds (3.2 ypc). Ohio is off a offensive outburst putting up a program record 664 yds in a 58-42 win over UMass as a 13' pt HF. They are led by QB Rourke who is avg 185 ypg (54 %, 6-2) and leads with 342 yds rush (9.8 ypc). Wit Ohio opening a close to a 2 td AF we expect KS to keep it closer in what should be an offensive battle.

**Eastern Michigan by 1 over WESTERN MICHIGAN** - WM has won 4 straight in the series but after covering the first 2 is 0-1-1 ATS the L/2. LY EM had a 461-422 yd edge but lost in OT, missing a 24 yd fg that would have sent it to 2 OT. LW WM trailed Miami 33-21 late 3Q but pulled out a 40-39 win as a 2' pt AF scoring the GW td with 2:53 left. LW EM forced OT scoring the only 2H pts on a Fg with :03 left but lost in 3OT loss to NIU as a 3' pt HF. EM is 2-1 ATS on the road this year including the outright upset of Purdue 20-19 as a 16.5 pt dog. EM also almost pulled the upset at SDSU as a 13 pt AD (lost 23-20) and is better than their 2-3 SU record and we will look for them to pull the upset here in a close game.

**AKRON by 3 over Miami, Oh** - Akron has won 4 of the L5 mtg but lost 24-14 (+6) LY. That was UA QB's Nelson's first career start and while he threw for 218 yds (1-0 ratio), he was sacked 6 times. Miami is off a heartbreaking 40-39 loss (+2) to WM blowing a 33-21 late 3Q lead. This is Miami's 4th road game in 5 wks, while Akron is off a bye. The Zips are 2-1 SU & ATS including a 39-34 upset of Northwestern as a 21' pt AD but that was thanks to 3 defensive td's in the 2H. This will likely be a very close game and so we will lean slightly with the HT,

**Illinois by 10 over RUTGERS** - The visitor has won & covered both meetings as B10 rivals. IL enters fresh off a bye & this will be their first true road game. After 3 straight losses by an avg score of 50-10, RU trailed Indy 24-7 at the half LW before adding two 4Q scores to lose by just a td. RU was outgained 451-291 & true frosh QB Artur Sitkowski remains the starter, but is still a work in progress as he's completing just 50% w/a 2-8 ratio. If there is something to be gained from this game its to see if the IL defense that is allowing foes to gain 122 ypg more than their avg can stop an RU offense that is being held to 90 ypg less than their opponents allow. IL is an AF for just the 4th time in the L7Y, but the last time in this role was their win here in '16.

**BOISE ST by 11 over San Diego St** - Boise has won the last 2 matchups in this series incl last ssn on the road where the Broncos were a road dog for just the 2nd time s/ joining the MW and won 31-14 (21-0 HT lead) despite being outgained 323-311. Boise comes into this game off of a 20 pt win (34-14) at Wyoming and had a large edge in both yds (506-214) and FD's (29-11). SDSt is off to a 3-1 start and is also fresh off of a bye, but will be without their top RB Juwan Washington (513 yds, 5 td, #5 rusher in FBS at time of injury) who will miss some time w/ a broken collarbone. The Aztecs rely on their run gm so that is a tough loss for the offense, who are also using a backup QB at the moment as QB Chapman battles an inj. Boise though is just 5-13 ATS as a home favorite in MW play s/2014 & SDSt is well-coached under Rocky Long. We'll call for the away dog to keep this outcome respectable.

**Liberty by 3 over NEW MEXICO ST** - The first of 2 meetings between these 2 TY as scheduling was not easy these 2 tms that are in their 1st ssn as FCS Independents. Liberty beat New Mexico LW 52-43 as a 7 pt AD and actually led 42-10 at HT. The Aggies lost to New Mexico 3 wks ago 42-25 as a 3 pt HD. Their only win was over a weak UTEP team 27-20 as a 4' pt AF, as they have struggled on offense this year avg just 18.8 ppg after avg 29.3 ppg LY. While The Flames should win here their are several factors against them, NMSt is off a bye, while the Flames are making their 2nd straight trip to the state of New Mexico and this is the first time LU will be a favorite over an FBS team. Weighing those factors, we expect this game to be very close to the line.

**North Texas by 31 over UTEP** - The home team is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series. NT ended a 3 gm series losing streak in LY's 45-10 (-23') win, though they actually trailed 14-7 at halftime. A week ago NT blew a 21-6 1Q lead, giving up 23 unanswered. The Mean Green held a 427-359 yd edge but missed a 2 pt conv that would have tied the gm, then later missed 2 4Q fg's. QB Fine was sk'd 5 times, noticeably limped during the 4Q and is ? this week (CS). The Mean Green also lost CB Hall and RB Easley during the gm (CS). UTEP dropped their 17th straight game, though for the second game they actually outgained their opponent in LW's 30-21 loss at UTSA (+10). QB Locksley rushed for 106 but was inj'd late (CS). The Miners won't hold the box score edge this week against QB Fine who completes 65% with a 13-1 ratio). NT is 3-0 as an AF and UTEP is 4-12 ATS run.

**Washington by 21 over UCLA** - It's been quite the struggle for Chip Kelly and the Bruins so far in '18 as they remain winless on the year following their 38-16 defeat last Friday in Boulder against the Buffs (21 pt avg margin of defeat TY!). The Huskies meanwhile had no issue getting past BYU a week ago at home as QB Browning hit on 23-25 for 277 yds in the 35-7 win (BYU's lone score came on a TD w/4:1 left following a muffed punt. LY's trip to Seattle ended in blowout fashion or the home team (44-23, -17') as UW rushed for 333 yds and finished with a 442-232 yd edge. While the Huskies have dropped their L9 visits in Pasadena with UCLA averaging a 36-22 victory, keep in mind that the Bruins haven't covered as a home dog since the 2013 season (0-5 ATS run!).

**STANFORD by 3 over Utah** - Following their 1st loss of the ssn LW in South Bend where we earned both a 4★ LP & 3★ Newsletter Winner on the Irish (ND 29-10 FD & 550-229 yd edges), the Cardinal return home where they've already gone 3-0 on the year with an 18 pt avg MOV. The Utes meanwhile moved to 0-2 in P12 play on the ssn after WSU dominated the #1 defense in the FBS with 28 pts & 445 yds (Utah had all'd 12.3 ppg & 204 ypg prior). In their 3 meetings as conf members the Utes have gone 3-0 ATS including a pair of outright upsets as 7 & 9' pt dogs. With Utah HC Whittingham an outstanding 10-2 ATS as an AD over the past 5 years and points expected to be at a premium here with Stanford RB Love ? with yet another ankle injury, we'll call for the Utes to stay within a FG in this one.

**Fresno St by 13 over NEVADA** - The visitor is now 6-1 ATS with Fresno covering their last 4 trips here. Tedford is 4-0-2 ATS on the road since becoming the HC here and is 4-0 SU on the road in regular ssn MW play with the average win by 14.3 pts and the closest win being 6 pts. LY Fresno jumped out to a 31-0 lead in the 2Q and ended up winning 41-21 with a 504-314 yard edge. Nevada returns home after 2 straight road gms and are off a narrow 28-25 win against Air Force as they went up 28-10 but had to hold on at the end to win. Fresno trailed 13-7 at home vs Toledo 13-7 in the 2Q but scored 6 straight TD's and led 49-13 by the end of the 3Q. The Bulldogs defense is giving up just 18.8 ppg & 314 ypg while the offense is scoring 45 ppg so far. Nevada's offense has been solid so far (scoring 38 ppg) but the defense is all'g nearly 37 ppg and 413 ypg while Fresno keeps trending up and we will side with the road favorite in this one to win by a couple of scores.

**Washington St by 20 over OREGON ST** - The Cougars rebounded from their first loss of the ssn a week prior against USC by earning a 4 pt win LW at home against Utah with QB Minshew surpassing the 400 yd passing mark for the 3rd time this ssn (31-56-445 & 3-1 ratio). The Beavers meanwhile were dominated in their trip to the desert with the Sun Devils putting up a ssn-best 558 yds (incl 396 on the ground). OSU dropped their 4th consec matchup against the Cougars a year ago with WSU finishing with a 491-354 yd edge in the 52-23 victory (-21). With WSU having gone 20-9 ATS in P12 contests over the past 4 years including a near upset 2 wks ago on the road against USC, we'll give them the 20 pt edge here as the Beavers have dropped 6 of their past 7 ATS prior to their bye week.

This game is being played at the Cotton Bowl in Dallas. The L/4 Red River Rivalries have been decided by 7 points or less & Texas is on a 5-0 ATS series run. OU hasn't won 3 in a row SU s/2010-'12. Texas led K-St 19-0 at the half LW w/a 191-64 yard edge & held on to win by 5 in the 'Little Apple'. OU QB Kyrle Murray didn't start LW vs Baylor (disciplinary) but entered on the 2nd possession & set career highs in pass yards (432) & td's (6) in the Sooners 33 point blowout win. OU's offense has finished with the most yards allowed by their opponents in 4 of their 5 games. The 'Horns enter with our #33 ranked PDR, while OC Tim Beck is expected to be recovered from the bacterial infection that left him hospitalized LW. Texas HC Tom Herman is 11-1 as a dog with 8 outright upsets (including an UD POW winner on these pages 2 wks ago vs TCU!) & we'll call for the 'Horns to pull off the upset here.

**FORECAST: Texas by 3**

**MICHIGAN ST by 14 over Northwestern** - NW has won & covered 3 of the L/4 mtgs despite being a dog in each including LY's 30T thriller. The Visitor is on a 9-2 SU/13-2 ATS run with the 'Cats owning 5 outright upsets in their L/6 trips here. NW enters on a 3 gm slide, but led Michigan 17-0 early 2Q LW before all'g 20 unanswered including the gm deciding td w/4:06 left. QB Thorson was able to play a full gm for the 1st time TY. Following the medical DQ of leading rusher Larkin, Moten got the 1st chance to take over as the str, but he managed just 36 (2.8). MSU led CM 31-3 4Q, but all'd 170 of CM's 245 tt yds on three 4Q scoring drives & only won by 11. Leading WR White was lost to a brk hand & RB Scott has missed the L/2 gms (CS). Sparty is all'g just 40 (1.5) rush ypg, but rank #55 in our PDR so it will be up to the arm of Thorson if NW can pull another upset. We don't think that will happen in front of the homecoming crowd.

**WEST VIRGINIA by 38 over Kansas** - While WV is 4-0 SU in this series as B12 rivals, winning by an avg of 29 ppg, the visitor is 4-0 ATS. WV needed a fast start LW in their win at TT, leading 35-10 at the half w/a 384-181 yd edge. The Mountaineers were outscored 24-7 in the 2H & held to just 105 yds. QB Grier remains in Heisman contention & is compl 72% w/a 17-3 ratio. After having success vs above avg pass D's the L2W, Grier should be able to put up video game like numbers vs KU, which ranks #59 in our PDR & is allowing 71% completions in B12 pl. KU QB Stanley earned his 1st start of the ssn LW as Bender was benched & Kendrick unavailable (shoulder inj, CS). It's homecoming in Morgantown & WV is home for the 5th time in 6 wks, while KU is travelling for the 2nd time in 3 wks. The Jayhawks are 20-36-2 as an AD.

**Alabama by 31 over ARKANSAS** - The Bama train keeps rolling, although after jumping out to a 56-0 3Q lead over Louisiana, they gave up 2 gbg td's, costing backers the cover. Arkansas has had B2B solid performances, losing to Auburn by 31 (held a +65 yd edge) & to A&M by 7 (+20). Obviously the stat advantage belongs to Bama who has scored 45+ pts in 5 straight gms for the 1st time in history. Despite the 1-4 start, Ark is only -4 ypg and their D is #7, holding foes to 121 ypg below what their foes avg in DC Chavis' first ssn. The Hogs have also held their L/3 foes to their ssn low yards. Given that Bama has failed to cover their L/2 and Ark has the best D that the Tide have faces, we will take the dog.

**Uab by 3 over LOUISIANA TECH** - The winner is in great shape in the CUSA West. LY LT (-11) scored a td but had their PAT blk'd to trail by 1 then had a fg blk'd on the final pl of regulation. LW we went with UAB as a 3★ LPS, and the Blazers jumped out to a 21-0 HT lead and won 28-7 (-16). LT is off an upset win over North Texas, though the Bulldogs were outgained 427-359 and fell behind 21-6 in the 1Q. LT is +100 ypg while UAB is +126. The Blazers avg 239 (5.2) rush ypg led by Spencer Brown who has 365 (4.6) on the ssn. LT has 13 sks on the ssn but UAB has only allowed 3. LT is on a 6-1 ATS run but UAB is 7-3 as a dog, already owns an outright upset this year over Tulane and is 7-1 ATS vs CUSA foes.

**TEXAS A&M by 10 over Kentucky** - Normally we suggest ply'g against tms that have been ranked for the 1st time in yrs, but the 'Cats avoided the letdown LW, jumping out to a 24-3 lead on SC & winning by 14 (E). KY's D forced 4 TO's & held SC to a ssn low 329 yds. A&M is off a closer than expected 7 pt win over Ark. 24-17 (-20). This is a matchup of the SEC's top 2 RB's in KY's Snell who leads w/628 (5.6) & A&M's Williams who has 582 (6.1). LW Williams rushed for 152 on Ark's D that came in all'g just 88 (2.7). The Aggies are #13, avg 124 ypg more than their foes allow & put up more yds than 3 of their foes have all'd vs anyone else. KY is #10 on D, holding foes to 117 ypg below their avg. Under HC Fisher they've covered all 3 at home & this is the 'Cats first trip to the 12th man in SEC play.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 3 over Iowa St** - OSU is on a 6-3 ATS series run & has won 8 of L/9 SU including a series long 6 straight. The Pokes enter off an easy win at KU, leading 24-17 (329-106 yds) at HT & cruised in the 2H. OSU has finished with the most yds all'd by 3 of their 4 foes as HC Gundy's system seems to flourish regardless of who the QB is. The lone tm that was able to shut the OSU OFF down was TT & ISU has a much better D. While ISU enters w/just 1 win, they've already tangled w/Iowa, Okla & TCU and has held 3 of their 4 foes to ssn lows in tt yds. ISU enters off an emotional loss at TCU as they all'd the GW 28 yd fg w/37 left. QB Noland threw for just 79 yds, but TCU has our #6 ranked PDR, while OSU counters with our #73 ranked PDR. ISU is on the 2nd of B2B away gms, but is 7-3 as an AD & 5-1 on the B12 road.

**GEORGIA by 30 over Vanderbilt** - The Last time here, Georgia was 2 td chalk and lost to Vandy 17-16. The Dawgs got revenge last year, beating Vandy 45-14 (-17) but Vandy has covered 4 of the L/5. Vandy enters off a much closer than expected 31-27 (-28) win over FCS Tenn St, though they did hold a 533-373 yd edge. Georgia also had a closer than expected win last week. The Dawgs led Tenn 24-12 4Q before adding two late td's to win 38-12 (-30). UGA did lead 24-0 at half w/a 207-68 yd edge. The Dawgs are #3 on D, holding foes to 156 ypg below their avg and they've held their L/3 foes to a ssn low yards. Vandy is +48 ypg and their D is #37, allowing 74 ypg below their opponents' avg. Under HC Smart, UGA is 4-9 as a HF and the Dawgs have LSU on deck.

**Iowa by 10 over MINNESOTA** - Iowa hasn't won Floyd of Roseedale 5 straight years s/2001-'05. Both enter fresh off byes. The Hawkeyes are travelling for the 1st time, while this is MN's homecoming. The Gophers have been held to under 300 tt yds in B2B games & Iowa is allowing just 261 ypg while holding their foes to 93 ypg below their season avg. Hawkeye RB Kelly-Martin was injured in the opener & missed 2 games, but returned vs Wisconsin & should be licking his chops at a MN defense that allowed MD to rush for 315 (8.5) their last game. Iowa is 13-2 as an AF. Each of the L/3 meetings have been decided by 7 points or less, but we'll call for the Hawkeyes to win by double digits.

**TOLEDO by 21 over Bowling Green** - This is a designated rivalry for these cross div foes but UT has won 8 straight (5-2-1 ATS) in the series. LY was tied at 21 late 2Q but the Rockets won 66-37 as a 17' pt AF (637-391 yd edge) but LTH BG only lost 42-35 as a 31' pt AD. UT is off a 49-27 loss at Fresno but led 13-7 in the 2Q when QB Guadagni was inj'd (CS). BG is 1-4 SU & 0-5 ATS & in their win over FCS EKY needed a 4Q comeback. LW we cashed an easy 4★ winner on these pages going against them. With their QB a ? UT could rely on their run gm, which isn't good news for a BG tm all'g 6.7 ypc & 212+ ypg rush in all 5 gms. There is no opening line to Guadagni's status, but UT should easily win here.

**Auburn by 7 over MISSISSIPPI ST** - LY Auburn was off 2 easy gms while MSU was ply'g their 3rd straight big gm & the Tigers dominated a tired Bulldogs tm 49-10 (-7). TY is a similar situation w/MSU off B2B physical losses (-127 ypg), while Auburn is only off Ark & Stmrn Miss. HC Moorhead has questions to answer after the potent Bulldogs OFF was held to 201 yds by KY & 202 yds by Fla. Now an even stouter D comes to town in Auburn who ranks #20, holding foes to 96 ypg below their avg. The Tigers OFF has struggled lately, only gaining 341 in their 11 pt win vs SM, but their D held SM to a ssn low 260 yds (226 below their avg). Aub allows just 93 (2.7) rush ypg. QB Fitzgerald has struggled in the new OFF, compl below 50%. Aub is 5-2 as an AF and this is their first 'true' road game in 2018.

**AIR FORCE by 6 over Navy** - AF is on a 3-1 ATS series run & is ply'g w/revenge. Navy surprised the Falcons LY, opting to ditch their typical triple-option attack in favor of NM's zone-option style & it resulted in the Middies finishing with their most ever rush yds in the series (471, 8.3). Navy enters fresh

The Middies have failed to cover their L/4 reg ssn gms away from Annapolis, while AF is 5-1 as a HD. **OLE MISS by 28 over ULM** - Ole Miss won all 3 of the most recent meetings by 44 ppg in '03-'08. The Rebels have faced two of the most stout defenses in the SEC in the last 3 weeks, getting drubbed by Bama and LSU. Last week vs the Tigers, Ole Miss (+10') was outgained 573-328 and outFD'd 33-18. ULM was absolutely dominated by Georgia St last week 46-14 (-7). The WarHawks go back on the road this week for their 2nd of 3 str road gms. Ole Miss is -35 ypg but that is scowed by their lopsided losses to Bama & LSU, and they did outgain a similar Kent St squad by 261 yds two weeks ago. QB Ta'amu and the NWO's (Nasty-Wide-Outs) will have a field day against ULM's pass D that gives up 73% compl and 300 pass ypg (#127 rated pass eff D). We will call for the Rebels to get an easy 4 td home win.

**MEMPHIS by 38 over Connecticut** - Memphis has won the L/2 meetings by an avg score of 56-21. The Tigers enter off a poor performance, losing at Tulane by over 2 td's despite being more than 2 td chalk. Memphis was held to a season low 277 yards & allowed a season high 496. Lucky for the Tigers a matchup with arguably the worst team (also perhaps the youngest) awaits. UConn's defense is so bad due to inexperience (7 frosh str's) that they even allowed Cincy's below avg offense to gain 234 yards above their season avg LW! Expect to see RB Darrell Henderson, who was avg 211 (12.9!) rush ypg the 3 games prior to LW, have a field day against the Huskies that is allowing 339 (7.5) rush ypg vs FBS foes!! TXST enters off a bye, but has an issue at QB after Jones was inj their L/gm & frosh Vitt took over. LA enters off of a 56-14 drubbing at the hands Bama. The Cajuns are 4-1-2 as an AF. TXST's D has fared well, all'g 357 yds & 30.3 ppg (both are improvements from LY). The history in this series has us leaning with the road team.

**RICE by 7 over Utsa** - They've split 6 mtgs w/UTSA winning the L/3 by 9 ppg, though Rice is 5-1 ATS. LY UTSA was -20 at home but only led 10-7 at HT & won by 13 (+134 yd edge). Rice has lost their L/4 & LW vs WF was only -44 yds but gave up 2 D td's & another TO led to an 18 yd td drive in their 56-24 (+27) loss. UTSA has had the privilege of ply'g B2B games vs awful competition, beating TXST & UTEP. The RoadRunners were outgained by 19 yds vs UTEP! Rice has the edge on OFF & D & is home for the 1st time s/Sept 1 so we'll take the Owls by a td vs a UTSA squad is on a 0-9 ATS run!

**BAYLOR by 6 over Kansas St** - KSU is on a 6-3 ATS series run & the dog has covered 3 straight. This is BU's lone home game in a 5 week stretch. While both schools enter off a loss, BU was trounced from beginning to end at Oklahoma, while KSU rallied from a 19-0 halftime deficit to only lose by 5. BU QB Brewer has taken firm control of the job & threw for 400 yards LW. KSU QB Alex Delton was ineffective & it was Skylar Thompson who nearly led the comeback, but inconsistent QB play overall has had an effect on the 'Cats this season. While BU is avg 488 ypg & finished with season highs in yards vs 2 of their 4 opponents, KSU has held each of their L/2 foes (WV & TX) to season lows in yards. BU is 30-17 as a HF, but KSU is 22-7 as an AD.

**MIAMI, FL by 9 over Florida St** - This is HC Taggart's introduction to this rivalry. Last year, in HC Richt's first meeting as HC of the Canes, UM broke a 7 gm series losing streak by getting a GW 23 yd td pass with just :06 left. Miami gets extra rest after crushing N Carolina on a Thurs night 47-10. The Canes only held a +75 yd edge but were aided by 6 TO's incl 3 defensive td's! FSU had to rally from 10 pts down to beat Louisville a week ago, getting the go-ahead td with 1:13 left after UL was int'd while up 3 pts inside the FSU 20. The 'Noles allowed UL to put up a ssn high 421 yds. QB Perry has been excellent since taking over, compl'g 66% (7-3 ratio). QB Francois has compl'd 63% (9-5 ratio). Miami certainly has the edge on OFF & D, but this is a heated rivalry and you have to expect FSU to put up a fight as a DD dog.

**WISCONSIN by 24 over Nebraska** - UW is 5-1 ATS in this series as B10 rivals. The Badgers responded to their upset home loss vs BYU by winning the Heartland Trophy at Iowa & enters fresh off a bye. UW has put up ssn highs in yds on 3 of their 4 foes & are holding opponents to 93 ypg less than their avg. RB Taylor has yet to rush for less than 100 yds. NU enters on a schl record 8 game slide after falling behind 27-7 mid 3Q LW at home vs Purdue. While the OFF is gaining traction behind the 2nd straight start from true frosh QB Martinez, the Huskers D has allowed 504 ypg their L/2 games including 237 (5.8) on the ground. The Badgers are 23-12 ATS in B10 home games & is 10-2 ATS off a bye.

**SAN JOSE ST by 3 over Colorado St** - These schls have met 5 times in the L7Y w/ 3 of the gms decided by 7 pts. Last ssn Colorado St rushed for 301 total yds and routed SJST 42-14 (606-339 yard edge). LTH Colorado St beat SJST 38-31 in 2014. The visitor is 4-2 straight up and 5-1 ATS the last 6 in the series. Colorado St is coming off of a bye, but sits at just 1-4 after a loss to FCS Illinois St 2 weeks ago. Grad trans QB KJ Carta-Samuels had been leading the Rams offense but HC Bobo indicated that heading into the bye that he would open the starting QB up as bkp Collin Hill will see reps with the 1st string in practice. SJST is at home for a 2nd straight week and is off a narrow 44-41 loss to Hawai'i that went into 5 OT's. SJST is on a 4-1 ATS run incl losing to Oregon by 13 despite being a 41.5 pt dog.

**HAWAII by 3 over Wyoming** - WY has won 7 of the L/8 in this series, but this just the 4th mtg as MW foes. LY UH finished with 24-11 FD & 450-269 yd edges, but all'd a 97 yd KR td & lost in OT. This decade WY has won just 4 of 32 MW road gms by 8+ pts. UH is back home after a close 5OT 44-41 win at SJST. It was their 1st win as MW chalk s/14. WY dropped their MW opener LW vs Boise 34-14 & was dominated in total yds (506-214) & FD's (11-29). The Pokes rely on their D, but is all'g 27.2 ppg (up from 17.5 last ssn) while the OFF is avg 18 ppg & 302 ypg. The UH OFF is rolling (495 ypg, 42 ppg) & QB McDonald leads the FBS w/2,100 pass yds & a 24-2 ratio. UH is 3-9 as a HF & we see this game being close.

### TUESDAY October 9TH:

**ARKANSAS ST vs Appalachian St** - 1st mtgs s/15 & the home tm is 0-2 SU. In their last mtg Ark St ran for 309 yds, rallied from a 21-17 HT deficit & won 40-27. Since 2010 the Red Wolves are 7-1 SU in SBC home openers while App St is 3-1 SU in SBC road openers. App St's OFF avg nearly 52 ppg & is torching D's to the tune of 524 ypg. The balance in the Mountaineers OFF is also impressive as they avg over 250 ypg both passing (254) & running (270). Ark St's OFF hasn't been the same TY, avg 27 ppg (10 fewer ppg than 2017). App St is 7-4 as an SBC AF & the Mountaineers look to be the better tm, however both sides will be well-rested as both enter off a bye prior to this Tues matchup.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ PHILADELPHIA over Minnesota** - Following a 38-31 pt defeat LW in LA against the Rams where they put up 446 yds but couldn't stop the LAR offense (556 yds), the Vikings head back on the road for another tough matchup against the defending champs in Philly. In their NFC Championship meeting of a year ago, the Eagles erased an early 7 pt deficit with 38 unanswered points in the blowout victory (456-333 yd edge). Despite a 17-3 lead LW on the road in Nashville, PHI saw the Titans storm back to eventually force OT and win it there (QB Wentz 348 yds & 2 TD in the defeat). While the Eagles do have a short week on deck with a trip to take on the Giants, they are on a 7-2 ATS run as a HF and should have no problem taking care of the road-weary Vikings here.

**FORECAST: PHILADELPHIA by 10**

**3★ CINCINNATI over Miami** - Following a surprising 3-0 SU/ATS start to the year for MIA where they had an 8 pt avg MOV, the Dolphins suffered their 1st defeat of the ssn LW in Foxboro in blowout fashion as NE jumped out to a 38-0 lead while cashing an easy NFL GOM Winner! The Bengals meanwhile earned the come-from-behind victory a week ago in ATL (8-3 ATS run) behind a rebound performance from QB Dalton (337 yds & 3 TD following a 4 int effort in the loss to CAR). Two years ago the Bengals delivered a 22-7 victory on Thur night holding MIA to just 8 FD's and 222 yds. With the home edge again in this one and MIA potentially showing their true colors now that they're facing better competition, we'll go ahead and give CIN a substantial edge as they're much stronger than we originally thought.

**FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 12**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ LA Rams over SEATTLE** - After a 7 pt win last Thur against the Vikings where QB Goff threw for 465 yds & 5 TD's, the Rams head out of town for the 1st of 3 consec road trips. LW the Seahawks survived in the desert with a 52-yd FG as time expired while keeping the Cardinals winless in the process (SEA 331-263 yd edge). While the Seahawks are on a 4-1 ATS run as a DIV HD, the last time in that role came back in 2011. In their trip to the Pacific NW a season ago, the Rams (+1) delivered a massive 42-7 beatdown (Gurley 4 TD's) for HC Carroll's worst defeat in his 8-year tenure. With the Rams improving their offensive production in each game this year and having covered 11 of their L/16 overall, we'll go ahead and call for them to take advantage of a Seahawks team that clearly doesn't have the defensive talent to slow this high-octane offense down.

## OTHER PLAYS

**Indianapolis at NEW ENGLAND - Thursday** - While the Colts won 5 of 6 contests from 2005-2009, the Patriots have turned the series in their direction since with a perfect 7-0 SU mark (4-3) that includes a pair of postseason wins. Following losses in 2 of their 1st 3 to start the year for the 1st time since 2012, the Patriots rebounded a wk ago to knock off the previously undefeated Dolphins by a 38-7 score (26-11 FD & 449-172 yd edges) while also cashing our Top Weekly Newsletter **4★** and NFL GOM in the process! The Colts meanwhile dropped to 1-3 on the year LW in an OT loss to the Texans (QB Luck 464 yds & 4 TD). With the Colts having covered 4 of their L/6 heading into Foxboro, it will be interesting to see if NE can improve upon their 16-6 ATS mark as a HF. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**Baltimore by 4 over CLEVELAND** - After a blown 14 pt lead in the 2H and an eventual loss in OT out West against the Raiders where QB Mayfield threw for 295 yds & 2 TD but had 4 TO's (1st career start), the Browns return home having gone just 5-14 ATS in their recent matchups inside of the AFC North. The Ravens meanwhile are in their 2nd of 3 consec road contests following a SNF win in PIT where they held the Steelers to 15 ppg and 169 ypg below their ssn avg. LY's Wk 15 trip to CLE saw the Ravens easily cash in as 7 pt chalk (27-10 victory, 376-266 yd edge) as they were still well within reach of the final WC spot in the AFC. With BAL having covered 13 of their L/17 games inside of their DIV including 5 in a row both SU and ATS against the Browns (13 pt avg MOV), we'll go ahead and call for the visitor to steal away another matchup here against an improved CLE squad.

**KANSAS CITY by 5 over Jacksonville** - The Chiefs are in the middle of a rough 3-gm stretch as they welcome JAX on short rest following a trip to DEN on MNF and having to head back on the road next week to take on the Patriots. After a surprising home loss a week earlier to the Titans as nearly a DD favorite, the Jaguars were able to get back on track LW against the Jets behind a defense that allowed just 12 pts, 10 FD's and 178 tll yds. The last 3 meetings in this series dating back to '10 have gone in KC's favor with a 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS mark and an 18 pt avg MOV. With the Chiefs also on a 7-2 ATS run as a HF and having the offensive weapons capable of putting pressure on the dynamic JAX defense (KC #1 in NFL in scoring at 39.3 ppg), they get the call in this one.

**Tennessee by 1 over BUFFALO** - While the Bills pulled out one of the biggest upsets in NFL history 2 weeks ago with a 27-6 victory over MIN as a 16' pt dog, they came back to reality LW in Lambeau as the Packers allowed just 11 FD's, 145 yds & forced 3 TO's in the shutout victory. The Titans meanwhile extended their winning streak to 3 in a row (all as dogs) following an OT win against the defending champs. In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Bills went into Nashville and claimed a 1 pt victory (ended 5-gm losing skid to TEN). With BUF in front of their home crowd for the only time in a 5-wk span (trips to HOU & IND on deck), we'll go ahead and call for a tighter than expected contest as the Titans are now a favorite and have failed to cover 8 of their past 11 away matchups.

**CAROLINA by 9 over NY Giants** - After a 2-1 start and an early bye week, the Panthers are back in Charlotte with a solid 15-6 ATS mark as a HF. The Giants meanwhile fell to 1-3 on the year after dropping a 33-18 home matchup against the Saints a week ago. CAR has done extremely well in the past 2 matchups in this series with a 38-35 win on the road in '15 and a 38-0 shutout victory here in 2013. While the Giants are on a 4-1 ATS run as a NDIV AD including an outright upset of HOU back in Wk 3, it's tough to go against a rested Panthers squad that's won and covered the past 3 years after their bye (6 pt avg cover).

**NY JETS by 3 over Denver** - Following a rough road trip in JAX where their offense was held to just 178 yds in the 19 pt defeat, the Jets return to NY for the start of a 3-game home stand. The Broncos meanwhile are just 3-10 ATS in NDIV matchups and are fresh off of a MNF battle at home against the Chiefs. In LY's matchup in DEN, the Broncos recorded an easy 23-0 shutout victory behind a suffocating defense that allowed just 6 FD's and 100 tll yds. While the Jets have been much more successful lately as a HD (7-1-1 ATS) compared to their 1-2 ATS mark as a HF the past 3 years, the Broncos are heading to the East Coast for a 2nd time in 3 wks and on short rest to boot.

**PITTSBURGH by 4 over Atlanta** - After a rough start to the year that saw a tie with the Browns and a home defeat to the Chiefs, the Steelers appeared to be back on track following a MNF win in Tampa. That momentum didn't last long however as PIT was held to just 14 pts and 284 yds in their 12 pt home loss to the Ravens on SNF. The Falcons meanwhile have had their own

share of recent struggles with non-conf foes as their ATS loss LW at home against the Bengals (CIN GW TD pass w/22 left) saw their spread record plummet to 4-13 against the AFC. While Big Ben and company will do their best to exploit a Falcons defense that's missing a handful of starters due to injury and has given up 80 pts and 941 yds over the past 2 wks, keep in mind that the recent history of this series has seen 3 of the last 4 end up in OT with a 4 pt avg MOV.

**Green Bay by 4 over DETROIT** - While the Packers entered LY with victories in 19 of the prior 23 matchups, the loss of Aaron Rodgers to injury saw the Lions earn the ssn sweep for the 1st time since 1991! Despite a gimpy knee still plaguing his mobility a week ago against the Bills, Rodgers (298 yds, 1 TD) got some tremendous help from his defense who allowed 11 FD's & 145 yds in the shutout win. The Lions meanwhile saw the Cowboys connect on a GW 38-yd FG as time expired (Stafford 24-30-307 & 2 TD). With DET on just a 4-12 ATS run as a DIV HD and the Packers looking for revenge, we'll call for the visitor to get the victory in "Motown" this week (GB 10-5 ATS as a DIV AF).

**LA CHARGERS by 7 over Oakland** - This series has seen a 2-gm sweep in each of the past 4 years including a pair of victories by the Chargers a season ago. The Chargers moved to 2-2 on the year following their closer than expected home victory over the 49ers LW. The Raiders meanwhile earned their 1st win of the ssn in dramatic fashion (trailed by 14 in 2H, GW 29 yd FG w/1:46 left in OT) against the upstart Browns in OAK (QB Carr 437 pass yds & 4 TD). While the Chargers are just 2-11 ATS in DIV HG's, trusting OAK as an AD (2-7 ATS run) may not be a wise choice at the moment with their inability to play a complete so far this year (blown 2H leads in their 3 losses).

**Arizona by 1 over SAN FRANCISCO** - Only HG in a 4-wk span for the 49ers as they return from a 2nd consec loss outside of the conf against the Chargers (29-27 defeat, +10) where QB Beathard threw for 298 yds (2-2 ratio) in place of the inj'd Garoppolo. The Cardinals meanwhile are the lone winless team remaining in the NFL following a home loss to the Seahawks where rookie QB Rosen hit on 15-27 passes for 180 yds (1-0 ratio). While both teams have struggled in this situation with the 49ers failing to cover 10 of their L/13 as a HF and ARZ just 2-8 ATS as an AD, laying points is a risky venture, especially with the fact that the Cardinals have won 6 consecutive meetings (3-3 ATS) by 12 ppg.

**Dallas at HOUSTON - SNF** - The Battle of the Lone Star State has lost some of its luster with a relatively ugly start by both squads heading in. The Texans saw their losing streak end at 9 in a row LW at IND thanks to a 37-yd FG on the final play of OT. The Cowboys meanwhile sit at 2-2 on the year (GW 38 yd FG LW vs DET) with their offense finally getting into gear (RB Elliott 240 tll yds). In their most recent regular ssn matchup in DAL back in '14, the Cowboys (-6') escaped with a 3 pt victory in OT. With DAL on a 19-9 ATS run vs AFC foes and the Texans covering 10 of their past 13 as a NDIV HF, this matchup has the makings of another tight finish.
