4★ STANFORD over Usc - Stanford suffered a pair of defeats against the Trojans a year ago as USC earned a 42-24 win at home in Sept and finished the season sweep w/a narrow 31-28 victory in the Pac-12 Championship. Following a 31-10 win over SDSU last Friday where they earned revenge from an upset defeat the year prior, the Cardinal have done well in P12 HG's over the past 5 years with a 16-9 ATS mark. They will have to get Heisman hopeful RB Love in gear however after he was held to just 29 rush yds (1.6) in the victory over the Aztecs (WR Arcega-Whiteside 226 yds & 3 TD!) as we won our 3★ on these pages. The Trojans used a 24-7 run in the 4Q to pull away against UNLV LW in the debut of true frosh QB JT Daniels (22-35-282, 1-0 ratio). A trip to "The Farm" could be a little more complicated for the young signal-caller in this one however (Trojans have dropped 5 of their L/6 as P12 AD's).

FORECAST: STANFORD by 14

3★ Air Force over FLORIDA ATLANTIC - First ever mtg between these schools. Air Force is just 2-7 in road openers SU but are an impressive 7-2 as an away dog the past 4 yrs. FAU is coming off an embarrassing 63-14 loss to #7 Oklahoma and will want to make up for their poor performance. While FAU might have the advantage talent-wise, they struggle to defend the option attack. Last ssn against Navy, the Owls gave up 416 rush yds (6.1) and 42 pts to the Midshipmen. Air Force averaged 307 (4.8) rush ypg last year and brings back 6 of their top 8 rushers. Lane Kiffin is 6-1 as a home favorite, winning those gms by nearly 29 ppg, but FAU is now 0-4 SU in reg ssn non-conference games and Air Force is 13-5-1 ATS vs non conference foes.

FORECAST: Air Force by 3

3★ INDIANA over Virginia - Indy has won 14 of their L/16 home openers with their only losses to #2 Ohio St LY & ironically to UVA in '11. While neither school has a ton of experience coming back from LY, Indy was able to go on the road & beat FIU, but no doubt infuriated their backers after finishing the game at the Panther 1 yd line & failing to cover by 1/2 point. Leading rusher Ellison was susp LW (CS), UVA has a new signal caller in JC transfer (orig AZSt) Bryce Perkins. He threw a pick 6 in his 1st series LW, but responded with over 100 rush yds & 4 tl td's. This will be his 1st career FBS road start. The Hoosiers are 3-1 as a HF, while the Hoos are on a 7-12 overall ATS run vs FBS foes. We'll call for Indy to win by DD's.

FORECAST: INDIANA by 12

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ ARMY over Liberty - First meeting. Liberty opened their first year as an FBS school, hosting an FBS foe for the first time and in front of an opening home game record crowd led 14-10 at HT and scored 38 unanswered in the 2H as a 6' pt HD. Army had an extra day after losing 34-14 to Duke on Friday as a 13' pt AD. The Black Knights struggled early with a fumble setting up a Duke 32 yd td drive early 1Q and trailed 17-0 at half. While Army replaces a 3 yr starting QB this year with Kelvin Hopkins, who is a little more of a passer and despite playing from behind it is still surprising that they passed for 197 while rushing for just 168 as they passed for just 361 total in their 13 gms LY. While Army was 6-0 SU at home LY they were just 2-4 ATS incl 1-4 as a HF. Liberty is now 8-1 ATS including 4 outright upsets on the road vs FBS teams s/13 and are under for FBS HC Turner Gill. Despite all that we look for Liberty to be in a bit off a hangover after all the buildup for their first game as an FBS team and the exciting win having to prepare for the option is not an easy task and will look for Army to put together a solid effort here.

FORECAST: ARMY by 17

2★ TEMPLE over Buffalo - Former MAC foes, these teams have not met since 2011 when Temple won 34-0 as a 21 pt HF. Both teams faced FCS foes last week. While the Bulls breezed by a weak Delaware St team 48-10 (led 34-3 at HT), Temple was upset by a ranked Villanova 19-17 in a in-city rivalry game. UB's QB Tyree Jackson threw for 6 td's but after his injuries LY did not have a rush attempt (UB's #3 rusher LY). Temple was lucky to only lose by 2 as they trailed 13-3 2Q but got back into the game with a 74 yd blocked FG return td and led 17-13 3Q. They were out gained 405-251 and out FD'd 26-16. Last weeks results give some value here as knowing that Villanova would be a 30+ favorite over DSU allows us to see the performances are closer than they appear. The Bulls are taking a much bigger step up in opponent than Temple and the Owls will have a bitter taste in their mouth. Look the Owls to get back on track this week.

FORECAST: TEMPLE by 13

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 7TH

Tcu vs SMU - This is the 98th meeting of the Battle for the Iron Skillet. TCU has dominated this rivalry, winning 16 of the L/18 including 5 straight by 19 ppg, however SMU is on a 9-5 ATS series run. The Shawn Robinson era got off to a great start LW as the Soph QB accounted for 5 td's in the Frogs blowout win over an FCS squad, while the Sonny Dykes era was the opposite for SMU, as the Ponies trailed 46-0 at NTx and at one point was outFD'd by a 27-1 margin!! TCU is 8-14 as an AF & on a 9-16 overall ATS run vs FBS foes, but SMU is 5-11 as a HD & has failed to cover their L/4 games overall.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 8TH

Uab by 7 over COASTAL CAROLINA - LY these two met for the first time and UAB led 23-5 early 2H but only won 30-23 (CC TD 1:19 left) as a home dog. UAB was one of the least exp'd tms a ssn ago, but brings a ton of exp back this ssn including 16 ret str's. UAB is also off a 52-0 home win vs an FCS foe. Meanwhile CC is off a 34 pt loss to South Carolina and is not as exp'd as UAB as they return just 12 starters and will need a new QB to step up w/ the loss of their starter. This is CC's home opener and HC Joe Moglia is back after missing all of '17. UAB brings back 9 offensive starters and will go against a defense that gave up 411 ypg in '17 and has just 5 starters back. The Blazers appear to have the better team and we like them to get the road victory here.

Georgia Tech by 7 over USF - First meeting and both teams come off easy wins over FCS schools. Paul Johnson has missed out on two bowls in 10 years and bounced back with 9-4 records the following year in both cases. GT has 13 returning starters incl QB TaQuan Marshall who ran for 1,146 (4.6) and All-AAC RB KirVonte Benson. USF has 11 starters back and has to replace their QB who was the school's all-time leading rusher, top 2 RB's, top WR, and 5 All-AAC defenders. The Bulls did add Bama transfer QB Blake Barnett who threw for 305 yds and 3 td's in his debut last week. Charlie Strong has yet to face a 'true' triple option team in his head coaching career but did hold Tulane's option to 194 (4.1) rush yards last year. GT is 6-1 ATS in road openers and on a 10-3-1 ATS run so we will take the Jackets by a td.

MICHIGAN by 35 over Western Michigan - Not surprisingly UM is 6-0 SU (avg win by 24 ppg) in this series between in-state rivals with the last meeting taking place in 2011. The Wolves

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have won 9 straight home openers by 30 ppg. New UM QB Patterson was under duress much of the night vs ND LW with the running game suffering as well, however WM is breaking in two new DT's and the struggle that UM's OL showed LW should be the opposite as they can gain confidence vs the Broncos, considering WM all'd 334 (5.4) on the ground LW vs 'Cuse. WM is just 7-12 ATS vs B10 foes and we expect UM to bounce back here and look like the potential playoff team that many people were expecting to see in 2018.

App St by 10 over CHARLOTTE - First mtg between these in-state teams. Charlotte is off an 1-11 ssn, but brings back 18 str's and are one of the more exp'd tms in college football. App St is off a 7-point overtime loss at Penn St (451-434 yd edge) and will be looking to get their first win of the ssn in this game. App St returns just 11 str's and has to replace 4-year starting QB Taylor Lamb, but in our eyes they are still the stronger team on offense, defense and has a huge ST's edge over Charlotte. However, App St is on the 2nd of B2B AG's, had an emotional loss LW & the 49ers were 3-1 a ssn ago as a home dog. We'll still call for App St to win by DD's, but for Charlotte to keep it closer than expected.

PURDUE by 14 over Eastern Michigan - These schools last met in 2012. PU is in a B10/SEC Sandwich, while EM is fresh off an FCS blowout win, but does have their first MAC gm on deck. We won our Thurs night Marquee LW going against PU in their outright home loss vs NW. QB Sindelar was rusty coming off an ACL injury and David 'checkdown' Blough also saw time. PU does have a legit playmaker in true frosh WR/RB Rondale Moore, who will no doubt give the EM D fits. EM only held 26-23 FD & 473-386 yd edges in their win LW. Eagles QB Wiegars is an Iowa transfer, but threw just 6 passes in 3Y in Iowa City and this will be his 1st career road start. EM has been competitive in this role as they're 11-1 as an AD, not to mention on a 18-5 overall ATS run and we lean ever so slightly with the Eagles here.

WISCONSIN by 35 over New Mexico - UW has won 39 consecutive non-conf home games by an avg of 27 ppg, while NM lost their road games by an avg of 25 ppg LY. The Lobos run the option, but the Badgers were able to work on defending the unique OFF during August. UW got off to a slightly slower than expected start, but was still able to handle WKU with ease LW as RB Taylor (Heisman fav) had a pair of td's (also another fumble) while rushing for 145 yds. NM has failed to cover their L/5 vs FBS foes, while UW is 6-4 ATS in the reg ssn vs non-conf foes. Handicapping this game is all about the trenches and UW has the best OL in the nation, while NM is replacing 2 of their 3 DL str's. The Lobos have a much more important and winnable game on deck vs their rival NMSU and after falling behind early here, will likely concede a blowout and not risk any key players going down this early in the season.

OLD DOMINION by 3 over Fiu - ODU is 8-1 in home openers (avg MOV by 45 ppg). The Monarchs have won 3 of 4 CUSA meetings vs FIU, incl last year in a 37-30 upset (FIU garbage td with :20 left. ODU returns 16 starters incl QB Steven Williams who was expected to be vastly improved in his 2nd year as starter. He struggled last week in a shocking 52-10 (-6) loss vs Liberty where they were outgained 595-301, though the score was only 14-10 3Q before things got out of hand. FIU trailed 38-21 mid 4Q in their 10 pt loss to Indiana (+10'). The Panthers have just 11 returning starters and have yet to settle on a QB as Bowling Green transfer James Morgan and Christian Alexander both played last week. We don't think ODU is nearly as bad as they looked last week and FIU is a young team playing their first road game (4-12 in road openers).

NORTHWESTERN by 10 over Duke - These schools are meeting for the 4th straight season. NW was surprisingly blown out LY in Durham & will have revenge on their minds. We were on the right side for both squads LW as we gave all our Power Sweep subs a free marquee winner on the 'Cats last Thurs as they pulled the outright upset over Purdue & Duke was a 3★ LPS winner after their win over Army last Fri. NW QB Thorson (legit NFL prospect) tore his ACL in LY's bowl, but was able to start LW however, TJ Green (son of former NFL QB Trent) also played several series. RB Larkin may soon have 'Cats fans forget about career leading rusher Justin Jackson after rushing for 143 yds. NW is 8-3 as a HF & is on a 10-2 overall ATS run, while Duke HC Cutcliffe is 6-9 ATS in road openers. We'll call for NW to get their revenge and win by over a td.

Arizona by 3 over HOUSTON - UH beat AZ on the road LY despite the 'Cats having a GUB edge. UH actually trailed in-city rival Rice mid 3Q LW before pulling away, while AZ was upset in HC Sumlin's debut at home. The 'Cats were simply overpowered in the trenches. UH has one of the most exp'd OLs in the nation for '18 and reigning Outland Awd winner DT Oliver is the likely #1 overall pick in next years draft. AZ QB Tate was one of the most talked about dual threat signal callers over the offsn, but hasn't been able to capitalize on his early career success as he's failed to sniff 100 rush yds in 4 straight games now. However, AZ is in revenge mode and HC Sumlin needs a win after LW's unexpected result. We'll call for AZ to pull off the outright upset.

VANDERBILT by 13 over Nevada - 1st meeting. HC Derek Mason is 7-2 ATS vs Group of 5 foes, but this is the first time they've been favored vs a G5 opponent by more than 2 td's since 2013. The 'Dores won their home opener last week over Middle Tenn 35-7, though they only finished +52 yards and were actually -2 FD's. Nevada put up 72 points vs an overmatched FCS foe last week. In last year's road opener they actually led Northwestern 17-7 3Q before losing by 11. However, lets not forget about the Commodores fast start LY, including knocking off Kansas St in non-conference play. We know that Vandy has ND on deck, but this is a team that shouldn't be looking ahead vs anybody and will put up a focused effort here and win by nearly 2 td's.

NC STATE by 17 over Georgia St - 1st meeting. NC State is 12-0 all-time vs current Sun Belt foes (average MOV 25 ppg) while Georgia State is 0-7 vs P5 schools incl a 56-0 loss at Penn State last year. The Panthers barely avoided losing their second straight versus an FCS foe last week, scoring the go-ahead td with just :41 left. The Wolfpack only led FCS James Madison 17-13 (-10') until they scored a late td of their own, giving their backers the cover. NCSt has a big non-conf matchup with West Virginia on deck and will focus on getting their struggling run game going (just 29-83 last week) but Georgia St has been solid against the run, giving up just 136 (4.1) ypg last year and they bring back 3 DL starters. The Wolfpack is 0-5 as a home fav while the Panthers are an excellent 20-6 as an AD.

OKLAHOMA by 24 over UCLA - OU showed no signs of slowing down despite having to replace Heisman Trophy winning QB and #1 NFL DC Baker Mayfield as Tyler Murray took over the OFF and was needed for not even an entire half in the Sooners blowout over FAU LW. UCLA has a new, but P12 familiar HC in Chip Kelly, however there appears to be growing pains after the Bruins were upset at home by Cincy LW. QB Speight was inj'd early (CS) and true frosh Thompson-Robinson was inconsistent. The Bruins all'd Cincy RB Warren to rush for 142 yds & OU has 1 of the premier RB's in the nation in Rodney Anderson, who ran for 100 yds on just 5 carries LW. UCLA has lost 11 in a row SU away from the Rose Bowl and is 3-6 as an AD, while OU is 45-25 as a HF & is on a 15-6 overall ATS run. There's no line at presstime due to Speights injury so we'll put our line at 24 assuming he plays.

UTAH ST by 24 over New Mexico St - Rematch of LY's Arizona Bowl that NMSt won 26-20 in OT. Utah St does hold a 30-8 lead in this series including a 21-3 mark s/1968 and will be playing with revenge. The Aggies are a very exp'd team coming off a near upset of #11 Michigan St and look like a contender for the MW title. Meanwhile NMSt is off to an 0-2 SU/ATS start, losing those gms by a combined score of 77-17 to Wyoming & Minnesota. Utah St is 5-2 ATS as a home favorite the L3Y and are off a loss with only Tenn Tech on deck. NMSt does return 15 st'rs, but are without their top QB, RB and WR. The visitor is 1-4 the L5 mtgs and we like Utah St to roll to victory in this matchup.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 10 over Kansas - Before the ssn started we had this game circled as the one where KU would finally end their embarrassing streak of 49 straight losses away from Lawrence. Fast forward to the present and there's no way we can put any faith in the Jayhawks despite entering this ssn as the most exp'd in the nation. KU proved they are still KU after falling at home in OT vs Nichols after being held to just 255 tl yds. CM only trailed by 1 at the half at KY after forcing 4 1H TO's, but were shutout in the 2H. CM beat KU by over 2 td's LY in Lawrence, but did have a Michigan transfer at QB and is breaking in a new signal caller TY. Still, the Chipp's are 14-7 ATS off a SU loss & have covered their last 5 reg ssn games, while the Jayhawks are 19-35 as an AD & on a 11-24 overall ATS run vs FBS foes.

UNLV by 28 over Utep - First meeting s/1993. UTEP is just 2-6 SU/3-5 ATS in their last 8 road openers scoring an avg of just 19 ppg. The Miners went 0-12 a ssn ago, ret just 12 st'rs and are off a 20-pt loss to Northern Arizona in their opener. UNLV brings back 14 st'rs including their star QB Armani Rogers and RB Lexington Thomas, who ran for 1,336 rush yds and 17 td's last ssn. The Rebels only trailed USC by 5 at HT in their opener and this is HC Tony Sanchez's best team yet. We like the Rebels to win by four td's in this contest over a UTEP team that has not won a game since November of 2016 and is on a 2-10-1 ATS run.

NAVY by 3 over Memphis - Navy has covered all 3 meetings as AAC rivals. While the Middies have won 12 of their last 15 home openers, they're just 4-3 SU vs FBS foes. Memphis has a new QB in AZSt transfer Brady White, who threw for 358 yds & 5 td's in his debut in less than 1H vs FCS Mercer. Navy allowed new Hawaii QB McDonald to shred them for 428 yds & 6 td's LW. Memphis had their best showing in defending Navy's option attack LY, only all'g 4.6 ypc. The Middies had a punt blocked & returned for a td & the Tigers consistently feature 1 of the best ST's units in the nation. Despite the numbers leaning Memphis direction we can't ignore the success that Navy has had in this series. The Middies are 4-1 as a HD and haven't began a ssn 0-2 s/2012. We'll call for Navy to bounce back this week and earn the upset.

North Carolina by 18 over EAST CAROLINA - NC is 12-4-1 SU in this series but have lost both meetings under Fedora incl 70-41 (+2) LTH in '14. The Tar Heels look to bounce back from a 24-17 (+7) loss at Cal in the opener. The Heels fell behind 24-3 4Q, but rallied for the backdoor cover on a td with just 1:13 left. The Heels actually outgained Cal 301-279 but 4 TO's incl a pick-6 proved to be their undoing. EC's opener was delayed until Sunday & they prob wish it would've been cancelled after losing to FCS NC A&T outright. The Pirates have 12 returning starters incl 2nd Tm AAC WR Trevon Brown. NC is still missing 10 players who are suspended incl LY's starting QB Surratt and their top DT Aaron Crawford remains out (inj). Normally we would lean with the HD in a game like this, but we can't put any faith in this Pirate squad at this time.

OHIO ST by 42 over Rutgers - OSU has dominated this series as B10 rivals, winning/covering all 4 meetings by an avg score of 55-6. The Buckeyes have outscored the Knights 114-0 the L2Y. OSU showed no ill-effects of not having HC Meyer on the sidelines LW & we used the Buckeyes as our B10/B12 complimentary play in their blowout win over Oregon St. New QB Haskins gives OSU a downhill pass threat setting school records for a 1st time starter with 313 pass yds & 5 td's. Meyer will be allowed to coach the team during the week, however he won't be allowed around the squad during gameday. Rutgers did open their season with a win for the 1st time under HC Ash, beating TXSt, which is arguably the worst program in FBS. True frosh QB Sitkowski did complete 20-29 passes, but also threw 3 int's including a pick 6 and is making his 1st career road start in front of over 105,000 fans. OSU is 6-2 as a 20+ favorite, while RU is 8-16 ATS vs ranked foes. The Buckeyes get another blowout win.

Georgia by 4 over SOUTH CAROLINA - This game returns to where it belongs, as the SEC opener for both schools. The home team is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in the series. SC is the more experienced team, returning 14 starters (#29 exp) and get WR Deebo Samuel back from inj while UGA has 13 returning starters but is only #85 in experience. Both tms come off easy wins in their opener. The Dawgs have failed to cover in 3 of their L4 road openers. Last year SC kept it closer than expected, trailing just 14-7 at half before losing 24-10 (+23). The Gamecocks pulled 5 outright upsets last year (7-1 as a dog) and while we don't think they will put another one, it's enough for us to take the points.

Baylor by 17 over UTSA - Baylor is in revenge mode after losing at home to UTSA LY despite being over a 2 td favorite! It was the Roadrunners 1st win over a P5 school in 6 tries. These schools are on opposite ends of returning experience for the '18 season and it showed in LW's results. We went against UTSA on these pages LW for our top play and easily cashed our 4★ as the Roadrunners fell at AZSt 49-7 (+17). Baylor had an inexperienced roster LY and was upset by an FCS school in their opener, but opened up this ssn with a win by 4 td's. The QB snaps were split between returning st'r Brewer & NCSt grad transfer McClendon, who was the sharper of the two hitting 10-13-173-2-0. Brewer inj'd his back & is a ? for this game. UTSA allowed 266 (7.4) rush LW & Bear RB's Hasty & Lovett each had over 100 LW. Baylor's D was a bit leaky LW, but we expect improvement here and have no problem installing the Bears as a 17 pt fav.

ALABAMA by 35 over Arkansas St - These two haven't met since Bama rolled to a 35-0 win in 2008. Alabama is off their usual dominating win in the opener, beating Louisville 51-14 (-24) and finishing with a 519-268 yard edge. Despite splitting reps with Jalen Hurts, Tua Tagovailoa still threw for 227 yds and 2 td's. Both QB's will likely play again this week. Ark St is off an easy win over an FCS foe and returns SBC OFF POY Justice Hansen. The Red Wolves are 10-5 ATS in road openers while Bama is just 1-5-1 ATS when they follow their national tv neutral site opener with a group of 5 opponent (only cover by half point in '14). This is a sandwich game for Bama with their SEC opener on deck against the best team in the SBC and recent history shows that they're just 2-11 as a DD HF vs non-conf foes.

NEBRASKA by 7 over Colorado - This is the 70th all-time meeting between these former conference rivals, but 1st since 2010. CU enters with a GUB edge as NU had their season opener cancelled due to weather. The Buff's had little trouble smacking their in-state rival around LW, but figure to get a much tougher contest in Lincoln. The already enthusiastic fan base figures to be even more vocal after having to wait an extra week to hear their voices heard. Nebraska typically gets off to fast starts as they're 10-3 ATS in their 1st game of the season and new HC Frost would like his new team to gain confidence. We'll call for NU to pick up a close win by a td.

Ulm by 3 over SOUTHERN MISS - These teams met LY for the 1st time s/1993 and S. Miss won by just 11, despite having a 534-330 yd edge over ULM. ULM is off a narrow 34-31 win over SE Louisiana, though they did hold 554-437 yd & 31-22 FD edges. Overall ULM is just 1-4 against the Golden Eagles. But ULM brings back 17 st'rs and are #20 in the FBS in experience while S Miss brings back only 9 st'rs and #108 in experience. S. Miss is just 4-7 as a home favorite under HC Jay Hopson, but looked good in their 55-7 (-34) week 1 win over Jackson St. The Warhawks have a potent offensive attack, led by QB Caleb Evans, and if they can get some solid play from their defense, ULM could pull the road upset here.

KANSAS ST +7' over Mississippi St

KSU is breaking in new coord's on both sides of the ball and it looked like it LW as they trailed 24-12 4Q vs FCS foe South Dakota. ST's (along w/HOF HC Snyder) has always been the equalizer for the 'Cats and it was a PR td that woke them up and jump started their comeback victory. QB's Delton & Thompson comb'd for 13-28-152-1-2 as neither pulled away in the race to become the full-time starter. MSU has a new HC in ex-PSU OC Moorehead, but also returns a wealth of experience that showed in their blowout win over Stephen F Austin LW. QB Fitzgerald will be back under center for the Bulldogs after serving a 1 gm susp (vio tm rules). However, its hard to overlook the fact that this is a rookie HC's 1st road trip vs one of the best ever in Bill Snyder. Since HC Snyder returned in '09, KSU is 20-2 SU hosting non-conf foes. The 'Cats are 10-3 as a HD and we'll back the HOF HC in his preferred role.

NOTRE DAME by 28 over Ball St - First meeting of these instate schools. Both teams faced Miami OH LY with ND winning 52-17 (-20') and BSU losing 28-7 (+18) but that was the Cardinals ssn finale after an injury plagued ssn. Notre Dame is off a HUGE 24-17 win over Michigan, a game they never trailed and led 14-0 into 2Q. After opening last Thursday with a n easy 42-6 win over a weak FCS team BSU has had a little extra time to prepare. After missing the last 9 gms last year, BSU QB Riley Neal seem healthy hitting 23-30 for 259 yds & 2 td's and running for 37 & a td. ND put up 302 yds against a strong UM defense but allowed 307. While the Irish will continue to get their offense in stride, BSU has back door potential especially with ND coming off such a huge effort in their opening win with SEC foe Vanderbilt on deck.

Iowa St by 3 over IOWA - This rivalry is played for the Cy-Hawk Trophy. The game is usually close as 5 of the L7 contests have been decided by 6 points or less, including LY. ISU is on a 13-6 ATS run in this series & the home team is 12-25 ATS. Iowa will have a GUB edge after easily getting by NIU, holding the Huskies to just 211 ttl yds. The Hawkeyes should return both starting OT's after each was suspended for the opener. ISU's opener was cancelled due to weather. The key matchup in this game will be the Iowa DL vs ISU's OL, which HC Campbell has said is the best in his tenure. Iowa is 13-22 as a HF, while ISU is 6-2 as an AD and we'll call for the Cyclones to pull off the outright upset.

Maryland by 14 over BOWLING GREEN - BG actually upset MD 48-27 (+7) in their only prior meeting in 2015. Dino Babers was the HC then, and current HC Mike Jinks is 0-3 SU/ATS vs B10 foes, losing by an avg score of 54-9. The Terps did it again. A year after going to Austin and pulling off a major upset, MD pulled the upset at home despite major controversy surrounding their program and their HC suspended indefinitely. Interim HC/OC Matt Canada's OFF was too tough for the players at LSU to grasp, but in less than a yr with a shortage of coaches, the MD players appear to have the system down just fine. (Maybe its the current LSU staff & personnel?). BG is 1-8 as a DD non-conf dog, 1-8 ATS vs FBS foes at home & on a 7-17 overall ATS run. MD's QB situation is still intact (3 QB's due to inj's 4 of the L6Y) & we'll call for the Terps to win by 2 td's.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 7 over Massachusetts - UMass put up 670 yds of offense against GS last ssn and won 55-20. Both teams bring back a fair share of exp on both sides of the ball, including both starting QB's. With their loss to Boston College last week, UMass is now 8-3 ATS as an away dog, but are off a tough loss and are on the road for a second straight week. GS won their opener against FCS SC State and ran for 319 yds, while allowing just 151 ttl yds on defense. GS is 0-5 as a home favorite the L2Y, but the Eagles are back to their option attack, have 18 ret str's and will be playing with revenge. We like the Eagles to win this gm by one score.

Clemson by 10 over TEXAS A&M - Texas A&M is 3-1 SU in this series but the last meeting was back in '05. Jimbo Fisher is familiar with Clemson, having faced them each of the L8Y as HC at Florida St, going 4-4 SU/3-5 ATS. Last year, Fisher's Noles were in a similar spot as a road dog vs Clemson and trailed just 17-14 until allowing 2 late 4Q td's. Both teams had easy opening wins over FCS foes. The Aggies return 8 starters on both sides of the ball. They have 4 starters back on the OL but face the #1 DL in the nation. Clemson was +153 ypg last year but only +40 ypg on the road. This is a tough one to call, but we'll put a slight lean on the 'dog.

MISSOURI by 21 over Wyoming - 1st Meeting. Wyoming has split their first two games in the post-Josh Allen era. They've averaged 328 ypg after struggling last week in their loss vs Washington St (outgained 394-206). They only trailed the Cougars 20-19 until 4Q and the last td they allowed came with :44 left. Drew Lock has crushed non Power 5 teams, with a 35-2 ratio over the last 2 years, and Mizou has won by an avg score of 61-25. WY is #16 in experience despite losing #1DC QB Allen (17 returning starters). Missouri has 16 returning starters and a massive edge on offense. The Tigers like to play the bully role against group of 5 schools and will show their muscles in this matchup.

FLORIDA by 18 over Kentucky - Kentucky has had chance after chance to end the nation's longest series losing streak, which is currently at 31 games (9-2 ATS) vs Florida. Three of the last 4 meetings have been decided by 6 points or less including last year when UK blew a 27-14 4Q lead. Now the Gators have better talent and their new HC Mullen is familiar with the Cats, having gone 8-1 SU/2-6-1 ATS at Mississippi St. Florida dominated an FCS foe in their opener while Kentucky only led C Mich 28-20 4Q though they did outgain the Chips' 427-255 (4 TO's). The Gators are #4 in experience and returns 19 starters. The 'Cats lost their starting LT prior to their opener, leaving them with 14 returning starters. HC Stoops is just 12-20-1 as an SEC dog and after so many close calls, Florida will return to dominating this series, winning by more than 2 td's.

Utah by 14 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - First meeting and Utah's first ever game vs a MAC school. Despite an early 10-0 deficit LW against Weber St, the Utes would go on to score 41 unanswered points in the 31 pt victory (25-3 FD, 608-61 yd edge). The Huskies meanwhile couldn't find their offensive footing (211 ttl yds) in a 33-7 loss to Iowa (4★ LP Winner on Under 47.5!). LY NIU fell just 3 pts short at home against P5 opponent BC as their late FG attempt hit the crossbar. While many visitors have said that trips here can be twice as loud as stadiums twice it's size, we'll go ahead and give the Utes the edge in this one as Utah is 16-7 ATS on the road the last 5 years including wins over the likes of Michigan, Stanford, Oregon, Washington and Arizona.

MINNESOTA by 3 over Fresno St - First meeting. MN true frosh QB Annexstad had little trouble in his debut LW leading the Gophers to a blowout win over NMST, but figures to suffer some growing pains vs an FSU squad that returns all 4 starters in their secondary & their top 7 tk'lrs overall. The Bulldogs put up 79 pts LW, their most s/1991 vs an Idaho squad that is in their 1st ssn as an FCS member after dropping from the FBS ranks, but were on the fortunate end of many short td drives after TO's & ST plays. FSU is 11-2 as a dog & on a 14-4 overall ATS run, while MN is 4-11 as a HF & on a 8-15 overall ATS run, but we will ignore those technical edges and lean with the Gophers.

Arkansas by 20 over COLORADO ST - This is Arkansas' first road game vs a non-P5 since 1999 (26-0 win vs SMU). New HC Chad Morris is implementing new systems on both sides of the ball. The Hogs QB is a bit of a ? after the opener with Cole Kelly starting but Ty Storey receiving the bulk of the playing time after the 1Q. CSU has allowed 44 ppg and 607 ypg in their 2 losses. The Rams biggest issue has been their pass D, having given up 537 & 358 yds (75%, 9-2 ratio). This will be a

big issue against Morris' spread attack 294 pass ypg in his last ssn at SMU. Arkansas is far more experienced with 16 returning starters to CSU's 9. The Rams are 1-6 at home and Chad Morris was 5-0 as a DD fav the L2Y at SMU. CSU is on a 9 game ATS losing streak and until that comes to an end, we can't lean their way.

† **Cincinnati by 1 over Miami, Oh** - 123rd meeting for the Victory Bell, the longest running non-conf series in CFB, and is being played at the NFL's Bengals Stadium. MU has lost 12 str but the last 4 were by 7 or less and usually in heart breaking fashion including blowing a 17-6 late 4Q lead LY, throwing an int with 1:07 left that Cincy returned for the GW td (21-17 +5). The RedHawks trailed Marshall LW 28-7 early 3Q but made a valiant comeback attempt losing 35-28 as a 1' HF. Cincy pulled the comeback upset at UCLA LW after trailing 10-0 2Q took a 17-10 HT lead and after UCLA tied it pulled away with 9 unanswered 4Q for a 26-17 win as a 14' AD but were actually outgained 306-304. While it would seem Cincy should be favored, this is an improved Miami team in a true rivalry game, where anything can happen. The dog has covered 5 straight in this series and we'll lean with the dog again.

TEXAS by 26 over Tulsa - First meeting. Texas had their 17 game home opener winning streak snapped LY after they were shocked by MD. They followed up LY's upset loss with a 56 pt shutout win over SJSt. The 'Horns were again shocked by MD & again find themselves needing a bounce-back performance. Tulsa enters with a 3-20 SU record in road openers. The Golden Hurricane trailed FCS foe Central Ark mid 4Q, but did finish w/a 493-247 yd edge. We'll call for Texas to get back on the right side of the scoreboard and take care of Tulsa by nearly 4 td's.

OKLAHOMA ST by 34 over South Alabama - Second mtg all-time, LY was the first matchup. OSU led 20-0 at HT and held Sala to a season low 175 ttl yds in a 44-7 (-28) win. Since the B12 was formed in 1996, OSU is 47-4 hosting non-conference teams. OSU is breaking in a new QB and will want him to gain confidence quickly. Sala is off a 30-26 (+10') loss in their opener to LTeCh. The Jaguars do return 13 str's, but still need to settle on a starting QB as 3 different players attempted a pass in week 1. Sala did pull an upset over a Power 5 team in '16 at Miss St, but this is HC Campbell's first road game and OSU is 8-1 ATS vs non-conf foes. The 'Pokes lost their top QB and top 2 WR's to the NFL, but still has plenty of talent so we will give them nearly a 5 td edge.

Penn St by 5 over PITTSBURGH - This is the 99th mtg of the 'Keystone Classic' and the dog is 8-1 ATS while Pitt has gone 7-2 ATS in the series. Last year Penn St led 28-6 4Q and won 33-14 (-21) although Pitt outgained them 342-312. Pitt has 9 starters back on defense and some believe this unit could resemble some of the outstanding defenses Narduzzi had at Mich St. Penn St has the QB edge with McSorely but they've got just 10 starters back. The Nittany Lions nearly dropped their opener to App St, scoring the gm tying td with :42 left before winning in OT 45-38 (-23'). HC Franklin is 0-3 ATS all-time when favored in road openers. Pitt QB Kenny Pickett already has an upset over a top 10 team at home under his belt, beating Miami last year in his first career start, and while we don't think Pitt will win, we do think they stay within a td.

BYU by 1 over Cal - The Bears head to Provo following a standout defensive effort LW against the Tar Heels where they forced 4 int's in the eventual 7 point victory. The Cougars meanwhile had an impressive win of their own as they went into Tucson and came away with an upset victory over Arizona (led 28-10 4Q, 392-326 yd edge). While BYU has gone 13-4 SU in home openers and have won all 3 regular season games against Cal (last meeting in '14), we'll be calling for the Bears to continue their solid run in road openers (won 4 in a row SU) against a Cougars team that we're still somewhat unclear on.

BOISE ST by 28 over Connecticut - These teams met for the 1st time in '14 in Hartford w/Boise winning 38-21 despite only having a 292-290 edge in ttl yds (INT & FR return for td). The last two years Boise is 12-1 at home SU, but have only outscored teams by 9.4 ppg. UConn is just 2-15 ATS the L4Y in non-conference gms and are off a 56-17 thrashing from UCF in their home opener. Boise does have a solid edge on offense, ST's and a huge edge on defense as UConn has just 2 starters back and 9 true fresh are in their 2-deep. Despite UConn's inexperience, we will lean with the dog here as Boise ST is just 13-31 ATS as a home favorite since 2011 and HC Edsall is 42-29 as a dog through his 2 tenures.

Michigan St by 7 over ARIZONA ST - MSU survived a scare LW over UTSt, but with a bye on deck figures to go all out here as they are 1 of the most exp'd teams returning in the nation and not only have B10 Title aspirations, but also playoff hopes. The Herm Edwards era got off to a sensational start as we went along with the Sun Devils, easily winning our top selection 4H on these pages LW. ASU was in command from the start vs 1 of the lease experienced teams in the nation, but will find things much more difficult this week. Sparty will be able to run the ball and QB Lewerke will also give the Sun Devils a look they don't often see. MSU is 23-15 ATS away from East Lansing, while ASU is 2-6 as a non-conf dog of less than 13 pts.

WASHINGTON ST by 38 over San Jose St - First mtg for these schools s/1996. San Jose is just 5-17 the L4Y as an away dog and are off a 44-38 loss to UC Davis in their home opener. Wash St had an impressive showing in their opening game against Wyoming, winning 41-19 and new QB Gardner Minshew threw for 319 yds & 3 td's. The Cougars put up 41 pts on arguably the MW's best defense, so against arguably the MW's worst defense they should have a field day. Also the SU winner in SJSt games is 44-6 ATS. Don't be afraid to lay the points here.

HAWAII by 14 over Rice - Rice is 5-2 vs Hawaii and they last met in '14. Rice has just 11 ret str's, a new head coach and is one of the least exp'd teams this ssn in college football. Hawaii also came into the ssn as an inexp'd team, but have looked good in their F/2 gms this ssn including a 59-41 win against Navy last week. New QB Cole McDonald looks quite comfortable in the Run 'n Shoot offense, throwing for 846 yds with a 9-0 ratio so far this ssn. Hawaii is 0-10 as a HF & we'll call for Rice to keep this one closer than expected.

4★ Tennessee over MIAMI - While the Dolphins enter '18 having covered 5 consec ssn openers, things haven't gone well under center the past 2 years with QB Tannehill missing 19 consecutive games with ACL injuries. The Titans meanwhile head to South Beach following a surprising playoff push a year ago that saw them deliver a shocking comeback win in KC in the WC round before being ousted by NE a week later. Despite the postssn berth, TEN parted ways with their HC in the offseason turning the duties over to rookie Vrabel here. In an AFC South division filled with talent and playoff potential, the Titans will need to get started on the right foot and continue their road opening success (5-0 ATS run). With the visitor in this series delivering 3 consec wins (25 pt avg MOV) and the Titans clearly the stronger tm heading into the yr, we'll go ahead and ride the streak here as TEN is a solid 9-4-1 ATS as a NDIV AF.

FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 7

3★ BALTIMORE over Buffalo - The fate of both the Bills and Ravens took a shocking turn in the final seconds a year ago as the Bengals' GW 49 yd TD pass on 4&12 with :44 left in Baltimore saw the Ravens' playoff hopes end while allowing the Bills to earn their first postseason berth since 1999 in the process. The Bills' roster has gone through a handful of changes since the end of LY however as starting QB Taylor moves on with rookie 1st Rnd DC Josh Allen potentially lining up under center in this one. With BAL having a solid 7-3 ATS mark in home openers and looking to get back on track following the late Wk 17 collapse, we'll go ahead and call for a DD victory in this one.

FORECAST: BALTIMORE by 13

OTHER SELECTION

2★ NY GIANTS over Jacksonville - While the Giants have failed to cover their past 6 home openers, they can't wait to get on the field here following last year's franchise-worst 3-13 overall mark. The Jaguars meanwhile were a blown 4Q lead away from earning their first Super Bowl berth. JAX has had their share of struggles in road openers over recent years as well with just a 2-6 ATS mark although they do return one of the league's top defensive units (#2 in '17 at just 286 ypg). With a new HC roaming the sidelines in New York and the fact that the Jaguars have routinely struggled against members of the NFC (3-18 ATS run), we'll go ahead and call for a mild Wk 1 upset.

FORECAST: NY GIANTS by 3

OTHER PLAYS

Atlanta at PHILADELPHIA - Thursday - After a narrow road playoff defeat LY in Philly where they had 4 shots at the EZ inside the 10-yd line late, the Falcons head back up North looking to ruin the Eagles celebration from their first ever SB title. PHI has some significant questions here at QB with SB MVP Foles expected to start with Wentz still recovering from his ACL. The Eagles do have some impressive spread marks entering play however as they've gone 6-1-1 ATS as a HF while covering 7 of their past 10 overall. With ATL also delivering an 8-3 ATS mark as an AD, this will be an exciting game to kick off the 2018 season! **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Pittsburgh by 3 over CLEVELAND - Following the second 0-16 campaign in NFL history (Lions in '08), the Browns head into the '18 opener having gone just 4-14 ATS against DIV foes. The Steelers meanwhile have had some poor spread records of their own lately with just a 1-5-1 ATS mark in road openers to go along with a 1-5 ATS run to close out LY's regular season. The Browns have gone through a major face lift since the end of LY giving the rejuvenated CLE fan base hope for a positive turnaround sooner than later. In a series that's been one-sided since the 2001 season with PIT having delivered SU victories in 29 of 33 matchups, the new look Browns should have an excellent opportunity to cover against the Steelers for a 4th consecutive time.

MINNESOTA by 9 over San Francisco - Although the 49ers head into Wk 1 following 5 consecutive covers to end the '17 campaign, the Vikings continue to be a cash cow for the betting public with covers in 10 of their past 11 regular season matchups. MIN upgraded their QB position for '18 with the massive FA signing of Cousins to go along with an already stout defense that finished in the Top 3 of nearly every statistical category a year ago. While the 49ers (8-4 ATS in road openers) appear to have their franchise QB under center following LY's acquisition of Garoppolo, expect MIN to get the job done here behind their outstanding 14-1 ATS mark as a NDIV HF.

INDIANAPOLIS by 6 over Cincinnati - In a very unusual scheduling lapse that saw the Colts travel to Cincy last Thur for the final week of preseason action, the Bengals return the favor by traveling to Indy here. In a midseason matchup a year ago at home, the Bengals narrowly got past a banged-up Colts squad by just a single point as 10' pt chalk (IND 331-276 yd edge). With CIN entering play on just a 3-7-1 ATS mark as an AD and Luck finally back under center with the Colts after missing 28 games over the past 3 years (including all of '17), we'll go ahead and call for IND to earn just their 2nd home opening cover in the last 6 years.

NEW ORLEANS by 14 over Tampa Bay - The Bucs appear to be in for a rough beginning to the '18 season as they head to New Orleans before hosting both PHI and PIT. The key to the 3-game stretch is that TB will be without franchise QB Winston after he was dealt a 3-gm susp. While the Saints have failed to cover each of their past 4 season opening matchups, confidence is extremely high in the "Big Easy" with a strong defense complementing one of the league's top offenses. Following an 0-5 DIV HF mark from '14-'16, the Saints were a perfect 3-0 ATS a year ago including a 20 pt win against the Bucs (-7) in the Superdome. We expect that recent trend to continue here as they seek revenge following a surprising Wk 17 upset LY in Tampa as a 6 pt chalk.

NEW ENGLAND by 4 over Houston - The Texans head to Foxboro for a 3rd consec yr with quite a bit of confidence after nearly cashing an outright victory LY as nearly a 2 TD underdog (3 pt loss, 417-396 yd edge). This was with a full squad for HOU however as the ssn quickly took a turn in the wrong direction following inj's to QB Watson and a handful of defensive players (0-5 ATS run to close out the year). The Patriots are just 1-4-1 ATS in home openers including a disappointing performance a year ago against KC when they were gashed for 42 pts and 537 yds. While NE was able to shore up their defense in the 2H of the ssn, the Texans' ability to move the ball on offense and potentially slow down Brady and company on defense should allow them to improve upon their recent 6-3 ATS mark in road openers.

LA CHARGERS by 1 over Kansas City - The Patrick Mahomes era begins this week for the Chiefs as they head to LA to take on a Chargers squad that they've won 8 straight against (6-2 ATS). The Chargers have covered 5 of their past 6 home openers and enter '18 as a darkhorse contender in the AFC with QB Rivers beginning his 13th year under center (192 concoc sts). While we'll go ahead and call for the Chargers to finally end their 4-year losing skid to the Chiefs in this one, it's hard to give them the spread edge with KC having gone 12-6 ATS as a DIV AD (Chiefs are also 4-1 ATS in road openers).

DENVER by 6 over Seattle - Despite their solid success over the past decade, the Seahawks have routinely struggled in road openers with just a 1-12 ATS run. The Broncos had a year to forget in '17 that included a 2-10 ATS run to close out the year. Things will be much different under center for DEN in '18 however following the FA signing of Keenum (11-13 LY as a starter w/MIN). Prior to LY's 1-3 ATS mark against the NFC, the Broncos had a solid 14-6 run vs non-conf foes from '12-'16. With SEA's identity relatively unclear entering the yr and the amount of newcomers expected to contribute, we'll ride with the home squad here as DEN is 6-2-1 ATS in home openers.

CAROLINA by 7 over Dallas - The Cowboys head to Charlotte with an outstanding 6-1 ATS run in road openers. Unfortunately their offense doesn't look as prolific as it once was following the release of WR Bryant and the retirement of TE Witten. The Panthers earned a spot in the postseason a year

ago and are just 3 years removed from a 15-1 regular season and a SB berth. CAR finished LY on a 6-3 ATS run and have also covered 5 of their past 7 home openers. Washington by 3 over ARIZONA - Following their 1st losing campaign in 3 ssn, the Redskins head to the desert having dropped each of the past 5 openers ATS. The Cardinals have been slightly below average in their recent home matchups with just a 10-13-1 ATS mark over the past 3 years (missed playoffs in each of the past 2). While ARZ's solid preseason performance may have some believing that rookie HC Wilks has his team heading in the right direction, we'll go ahead and back the visitor here as newly added QB Smith has plenty of weapons at his disposal to light up the scoreboard for the Redskins!

Chicago at GREEN BAY - SNF - The Packers have owned this series dating back to 2009 with a 17-3 SU (15-5 ATS) mark. The Bears are however a young up-and-coming squad that showed quite a bit of fight LY with rookie QB Trubisky under center. CHI has struggled as a DIV AD with a 6-17-1 ATS mark while GB has flourished with an 18-8 ATS mark as a DIV HF. With the line likely being a tad elevated by the time kickoff rolls around with Rodgers back under center for the Packers, check back on gameday to see which way we decide to lean. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

NY Jets at DETROIT - MNF - The Lions have done relatively well in ssn openers lately with a 6-2 ATS mark. New HC Patricia will face a familiar foe in his 1st game on the sidelines as he took on the Jets twice a year during his time as DC of the Patriots. Following a surprising start to '17 where they began the year at 3-2 including 3 straight upset victories, the rest of the year was worth forgetting for the Jets. It appears that rookie 1st Rnd DC Darnold will earn the start here as they attempt to improve upon a 3-7-2 ATS mark as an AD.
