## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ BAYLOR over Duke** - The revenge tour continues for Baylor this week. The Bears got their revenge last week at UTSA as it was Charlie Brewer who got the majority of the snaps under center after Jalan McClendon handled most of the duties wk 1 (Brewer was also banged up) & he responded by hitting 23-34-328-3-0. Duke is on the second of B2B away games following their costly win at Northwestern as not only did they lose starting QB Daniel Jones to injury, but also 1st Tm ACC CB Mark Gilbert, who their defense is built around. Both are likely out multiple weeks. The Blue Devils final score last week was misleading as they were outFD'd 23-14 & outgd'd 381-301. Baylor is 29-16 as a HF and we'll call for them to get their revenge.

**FORECAST: BAYLOR by 13**

**3★ West Virginia over NC STATE** - The only recent meeting was back in 2010, a 23-7 bowl win for NCSt. This is a matchup of two explosive pass offenses led by possible early draft picks at QB in NCSt's Ryan Finley and WV's Will Grier. The Wolfpack only have 3 starters back from last year's D but the secondary is the most experienced unit on the D. They've held their foes to 222 pass ypg in their F/2 but they've also allowed 67% completions which will be an issue against the likes of WV's offense. WV has been far more balanced, putting up 586 ypg (204 rush ypg, 383 pass ypg) and QB Grier has completed an astonishing 77% (9-1 ratio). NCSt hasn't been nearly as balanced, rushing for just 99 ypg (3.3) while passing for 368 ypg. The Mountaineers are more experienced (#72 vs #92) and have edges on OFF, D & ST's & we'll call for WV to win by double-digits.

**FORECAST: West Virginia by 17**

**3★ Arizona St over SAN DIEGO ST** - Arizona St is off of a thrilling 16-13 home win vs #15 Michigan St and will be playing with legitimate revenge after SDSt snapped the Sun Devils' 17 game non-conference home winning streak last ssn. Added into the mix is the fact that SDSt's DC the past 3 ssn's is now in that same role with the Sun Devils, so he is quite familiar with the players on the Aztec roster. SDSt's secondary will be in for a tough test as they face arguably the best WR in college football in N'Keal Harry. In week 1 the Aztec DB's allowed Stanford's top WR JJ Arcega-Whiteside to catch 6 passes for 226 yds and 3 td's. Arizona St does have Washington on deck, but the revenge factor will prevent the Sun Devils from overlooking this game.

**FORECAST: Arizona St by 10**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Miami, FI over TOLEDO** - The Rockets will be fired up to host a P5 foe in the Glass Bowl but Miami has won/covered their L3 'true' road openers by 29 ppg, with two of those also being at G5 schools. Miami, off a 21 day layoff, trailed 16-10 at half a year ago, and only led 38-30 mid 4Q before adding 2 late td's. The Canes did put up ssn highs of 52 pts & 587 yds against Toledo in last year's meeting. Toledo is off an early bye and returns 6 starters on both sides of the ball while Miami has 7 back on both sides. Mitchell Guadagni made his first career start 2 weeks ago and faces a Canes secondary that is led by two All-ACC performers and was #30 in pass eff D last year. Toledo hasn't been a home dog since '14 and are 1-4 in this rare role. Miami is on a 2-8 ATS run but we will call for them to win by over 2 td's.

**FORECAST: Miami, FI by 17**

**2★ UAB over Tulane** - After an easy shutout over FCS Savannah St in their opener, we went against UAB as a part of our 'Big Dogs' PPH package that featured not one, but two DD outright upset winners! You can get our 'Big Dogs' every Wednesday for just \$9 at the all-new ncsports.com website! The Blazers all'd 296 (6.9) rush yds! Tulane rebounded from their opening week loss vs WF to beat FCS Nicholls LW. Their spread option OFF is clicking and they should have little trouble again this week, but we can't discount the fact that the Green Wave is travelling for the 1st time with a trip to OSU on deck. UAB is 15-4 as a home dog and pulled 3 outright upsets last year. Tulane is also just 14-57 SU away. We'll call for UAB to get back on track and pull off the minor upset at home.

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 13TH

**Boston College at WAKE FOREST** - The home team has lost 4 straight in this series. Last year WF scored 21 points off 4 TO's and won 34-10 (E) despite the yards only being 309-305. This game features two of the most experienced OLs in the country with BC returning all 5 starters (139 car sts) while WF has 4 returning starters after the loss of LT Justin Herron (OFY). WF QB Hinton is still susp, and true frosh Sam Hartman has started the first 2, throwing for 310 ypg but he's facing LY's #1 rated pass eff D. BC QB Anthony Brown has looked excellent after coming back from LY's knee injury and the Eagles have one of the top RB's in the country in AJ Dillon who has rushed for 247 (9.5) in 2 games. BC was 7-1 ATS in ACC play last year. WF is 10-2-1 as a dog the last two years and 11-4-1 ATS vs ACC foes.

### FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 14TH

**Georgia St at MEMPHIS** - Memphis is 14-0 in non-Saturday regular season games s/2014. Memphis is off of a tough AAC East division game at Navy, where they lost 22-21 and are entering this gm on short rest. Brady White continues to impress and the Georgia St secondary only has one starter back from last ssn, so White could be in for another big day, while the Memphis run game is off B2B impressive performances. Georgia St returns just 11 ret st's this year and will also be playing on short rest as the Panthers off a tough road gm against NC State where they were blown out 41-7. Memphis is surely going to be a DD favorite, a role they performed well in a ssn ago, going 5-2 ATS when favored by DD. The Panthers actually played better on the road last year (+53 ypg), but are ranked 113th in experience, so we will lean with the more talented and experienced Memphis team in this game.

### SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 15TH

**TENNESSEE by 35 over Utep** - First mtg since 1990. Tennessee has won their last 15 gms vs CUSA schools by 23 ppg. The Vols cruised to a 59-3 (-38) win over FCS East Tenn St a week ago. UTEP has continued where they left off from last year, starting 0-2 including last week's 52-24 (+23) loss to UNLV that we used as our Early Bird POW (Free every Monday on Button #9). The Vols have their annual clash with Florida on deck but HC Pruitt wants to make sure his young team is fully prepared and UTEP, who is on an 0-7-1 ATS run, still hasn't settled on a quarterback, so we don't mind backing the Vols here.

**INDIANA by 14 over Ball St** - BSU is 6-1 ATS in this series between in-state rivals. Down their top 2 RB's, IU went with true frosh Stevie Scott LW & he responded w/204 (6.6) in their win over UVA. While BSU is on their 2nd straight away game, they will again remain in the same state. The Cardinals were able to hold N Dame to 117 (2.9) rush yds in their closer than expected contest LW. IU has their B10 opener vs MSU on deck, while BSU will host WKU. The Hoosiers are 9-6 vs non-conf foes (0-2 TY) while the Cardinals are 36-19 as an AD & 10-2 ATS on the road vs the B10. With a healthy QB Neal under center for BSU, we'll call for the Cardinals to keep this game closer than expected.

**MARYLAND by 10 over Temple** - The road team in this series is 6-0 ATS. After their 2nd straight season opening outright upset win over Texas, MD was in a letdown spot LW & trailed at BG at the half before scoring 35 straight in the 2H. The Terps finished w/a 565-158 yd edge including 444-15 on the ground! RB's Ty Johnson & Tayon Fleet-Davis each had 100+. TU is off to another slow start under HC Collins. After st'g LY 0-4 ATS they're 0-2 SU/ATS TY, being outright upset at home on both occasions. Trailing by a td LW vs Buf, Owls QB Nutile was sacked & fumbled near midfield w/55. Both schools have their conf openers on deck with TU hosting Tulsa on a short wk & MD hosting MM. TU is 13-6 as an AD, while MD is 3-17 ATS off a SU win. While both schools are starting their ssn's going opposite paths, we'll back the dog in their pref'd role as Temple is more dangerous than what they've shown.

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**FIU by 7 over Massachusetts** - The home team is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series. UMass is 2-1 SU/ATS but FIU won last year's meeting which was also the last time here. FIU set school record's with 63 pts and 674 yards vs the Minutemen in an 18 pt win. Last week the Panthers, on the road, rallied from a 17-0 deficit and after a long weather delay, beat Old Dominion 28-20 (E). The Panthers held FIU to just 90 2nd half yards and all 4 of their td drives covered over 75 yards as they held 489-396 yd & 25-16 fd edges. UMass enters off a 34-13 (+2) loss where they were outgained 488-323. FIU struggled as a HF last year (0-3) but this is UMass' 3rd consecutive road game and FIU is on a 7-2-1 ATS run. **Hawaii by 3 over ARMY** - Hawaii is 3-0 all time in the series but have not met s/2013. Hawaii dedicated extra practice time over the summer to stopping the option, and just played Navy 2 weeks ago. Army found their offense in week 2 after struggling week 1 and are just 5-9 as a HF the L4Y. Despite going 6-0 at home a ssn ago, Army only won their home games by an avg of 5.4 ppg vs FBS foes with the largest win being by 14. Hawaii is off to their first 3-0 start since their memorable 2007 ssn and have been quite effective in the Run 'N Shoot offense. Army's secondary doesn't practice against pass happy offenses and Cole McDonald has been stellar as UH's new QB, throwing for 388 ypg w/a 13-0 ratio. UH has already gone on the road TY & pulled an outright upset as a DD dog & we'll call for them to pull off another upset this week.

**PENN ST by 28 over Kent St** - No surprise that PSU has dominated this series, going 5-0 & winning by a comb'd score of 144-29. Following their scare vs App St in the opener the Nittany Lions led in-state rival Pitt by 8 at the half LW before scoring 37 unanswered in the 2H. Despite the lopsided score, PSU only finished w/a 390-300 yd edge as they benefited from 3 td drives under 50 yds, a safety & a PR td. KSU is running a new hurry up OFF under new HC Sean Lewis that was clicking on all cylinders in their blowout win over FCS Howard LW. This was following their near upset at IL in week 1. The Nittany Lions have their B10 opener at IL on a short wk on deck, while the Flashes will be travelling south to SEC country Ole Miss. PSU won't have any problems winning this game, but we feel the Flashes have backdoor potential in this one & will side with the dog.

**Ucf by 10 over NORTH CAROLINA** - This is actually the Tar Heels' home opener after dropping B2B road games to start the season, including last week's shocking 41-19 (-16) loss at E Carolina. The Heels led 16-14 2Q but were held to just 3 FD's and 81 yds as they were shutout in the 2H. UCF is well rested off an easy win over an FCS foe. The Knights have 12 starters back from last year's undefeated team incl Mackenzie Milton who has picked up right where he left off, throwing for 295 ypg in their F/2. NC is still dealing with 10 players being susp incl last year's starting QB Surratt. Nathan Elliott has completed just 51% of his passes (1-4 ratio) and UCF has 3 starters back from a secondary that finished #45 in pass eff D last year. While we feel UCF will get a DD win over UNC, nearly 2 td's is a little high in our estimation.

**Old Dominion by 6 over CHARLOTTE** - ODU is 3-0 SU but only 1-2 in this series. Charlotte is playing their 3rd straight home game but the visitor is actually 3-0 SU/ATS. The 49ers played in front of a record home crowd but were held to 203 yards in last week's 45-9 (+14) home loss to App St. The 49ers split reps between QB's Chris Reynolds and Hasaan Klugh and it remains to be seen who will start vs ODU. The Monarchs had high expectations entering '18 but those have diminished thanks to an 0-2 start. Last week ODU led FIU 17-0 2Q. With a 20-14 lead, a nearly 2 hour weather day occurred, and ODU couldn't get their offense going again as they lost 28-20 (E). A big reason for ODU's struggles has been a disappointing run game, avg 111 (3.4) ypg. With both offenses struggling, and last year's meeting finishing with just 6 ttl points, could we use the UNDER for this week's Totals GOM?

**Florida St by 6 over SYRACUSE** - FSU is 5-0 SU/3-2 ATS in ACC meetings, winning those by 26 ppg. By far, the closest matchup was last year when FSU won 27-24 (-6) thanks to a blocked fg on the games final play. The 'Noles are just 2-5 ATS in road openers. FSU seems to be struggling to pick up HC Taggart's system after barely beating FCS Samford. The Noles, missing 2 starting OL, trailed 26-21 4Q before getting 2 late td's. Samford actually held a 525-454 yard edge and FSU was +4 TO's. FSU will look to take advantage of a Cuse defense that has allowed 51 ppg in their L4 games vs FBS foes going back to last year. QB Dungey threw for 278 vs FSU last year and the 'Noles just allowed 475 pass yds vs Samford. The 'Noles were 0-6-2 ATS vs ACC foes last year. Cuse owns wins over VT and Clem in the L2Y but is just 5-9 ATS at home under Babers.

**Oklahoma by 13 over IOWA ST** - OU enters in revenge mode after blowing a 14 pt lead & losing at home LY, which snapped their 18 series winning streak. QB Kyler Murray is thriving as Baker Mayfield's replacement, hitting 64% w/ 7 ttl td's & just 1 int. The Sooners win over UCLA LW maybe costly as RB Rodney Anderson injury hit his knee 1Q & is OFY. OU may get a break however, after ply'g a UCLA team st'g a bkp QB, ISU st'r Kyle Kempt suffered a knee inj LW vs in-state rival Iowa (CS) & his bkp Zeb Noland (strong arm, but inaccurate) was just 4-10-43-0-0. ISU RB David Montgomery was held in check LW, but should be able to find more running room TW. ISU is 7-3 as a HD, but OU is 19-10 ATS away. Both schls have non-conf games on deck & we'll call for OU to exact their revenge and win by just under 2 td's.

**NEBRASKA by 16 over Troy** - The Scott Frost era didn't start off as planned as NU not only dropped their opener, but also true frosh Adrian Martinez, who was dazzling in his debut completing 75% while rushing for 117 (7.8) was inj'd late (CS). Bkp walk-on Andrew Bunch att'd to rally the 'Huskies late, but his final pass fell incomplete out of the endzone from the Colorado 20 on the games final play. Still NU looked improved after finishing w/329 rushing yds (most s/'14) & 7 sks (just 14 LY). Following their blowout loss to Boise in their opener, Troy responded w/a expected blowout over FCS FAMU. Trojans QB Kaleb Barker will be making his 1st car road start in an ultra-hostile environment & Troy has their SBC opener on deck. NU has their B10 opener on deck, a road trip to Michigan. The 'Huskies are 7-4 ATS off a SU home loss, but the Trojans are 9-1 as an AD. As long as Martinez is able to return, we'll back NU by over 2 td's.

**KANSAS by 3 over Rutgers** - We talked about KU's 46 gm losing streak away from home on these pages LW & weren't totally shocked after they snapped the streak by dominating CM, finishing +6 TO's & all'g just 1 FD & 60 yds in the 1H. The Jayhawks have a solid chance at B2B wins after RU st'g QB Artur Sitkowski was inj'd (CS) in their blowout loss at Ohio St. The Knights are on the 2nd of B2B away games & HC Chris Ash is 1-10 SU on the road. RU is on an 8-4 overall ATS run, while KU is on a 12-24 overall ATS run. This is a tough game to call and we'll side with the home team by a fg. **VIRGINIA TECH by 24 over East Carolina** - VT has dominated EC in their last 2 meetings, winning 64-17 (-24) on the road last year and 54-17 (-13) at home in '16. VT is 2-0 SU/ATS after beating FCS William & Mary 62-17 (-42). EC bounced back off a loss to an FCS foe by shocking N Carolina 41-19 (+16) at home, giving HC Montgomery a signature win. VT had just 4 starters back from LY's D to start the ssn, but they haven't skipped a beat, holding their F/2 foes to 297 ypg. The Hokies put up a ssn high 675 yards vs EC last year, though the Pirates D does seem immensely improved after allowing 332 ypg in their F/2 (542 ypg all'd LY). Under Montgomery, EC is just 1-9-1 ATS on the road while HC Fyette is 8-4 as a HF, but we will go against the technical edges & feel that EC keeps this game closer than expected.

**PITTSBURGH by 3 over Georgia Tech** - GT is 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS in 4 ACC meetings. The Jackets enter off a disappointing 49-38 (-3) loss at USF. Up 38-35, GT fumbled at the USF 19, which led to the Bulls' go ahead TD. The Jackets held a 595-426 yard edge but 2 KR td's proved to be a big difference. Pitt was crushed 51-6 (+7) vs rival Penn St. They only trailed 14-6 at HT while playing in a driving rain storm but fell apart in the 2H thanks to a combination of poor ST's play, penalties, and TO's (Pitt only outgained 390-300 & were +60 yds in 1H). GT is playing B2B road games and they are 0-7 now as an AF. GT ran for 436 (6.5) last year but Pitt's entire front 7 on D is back so they should be better prepared for the option. Pitt is 10-4 as an ACC dog and we will give them the edge by a fg.

**NOTRE DAME by 21 over Vanderbilt** - ND leads the series 2-0 incl a 14-7 win in their last mtg in the '96 ssn opener. Both come in at 2-0 SU. Vandy is 2-0 ATS covering by 21+ against both MT & Nevada. Last week they did only lead Nevada 17-10 at HT but scored 24 unanswered in the 2H finishing with 25-14 FD & 468-250 yd edges. After upsetting Michigan as a 2<sup>nd</sup> pt HD in the opener, the Irish only led Ball St 14-6 at HT as a 34.5' HD and while they led 24-6 into the 4Q they needed to hang on as the Cardinals pulled with in 8 with 1:30 left 4Q but ND recovered the onside kick. ND was actually out FD'd 24-20 and only finished with a 414-349 yd edge. ND QB Wimbush has been struggling this year as while he has thrown for 234 ypg he has a poor 1-4 ratio after throwing 3 int vs Ball St. While Vandy QB Shurmur is avg 214 ypg with a 4-0 ratio, he will face a much tougher defense here. ND has the Off edge (#20-#77) and Def edge (#11-#57) and that talent edge should show here after suffering some Big game(Mich) hangover effect last week.

**Ohio by 3 over Virginia** - UVA is 12-2 SU vs current MAC members. Ohio has just 12 returning starters from last year's squad while UVA has 15, but overall the Bobcats come in far more experienced (#43 vs #112). UVA enters off a 20-16 (+5) loss at Indiana. The 'Hoos were outgained 387-294 but did end the game on the IU27. Ohio is well rested off a bye and is 8-4 SU/ATS in road openers. The Bobcats strong run game will try to take advantage of a Virginia D that allowed 237 (5.4) rush yds last week. UVA QB Perkins has topped 100 rush yds in B2B games but has also completed just 52% of his passes. Ohio is 10-3 as a dog & while this game is key to UVA's bowl hopes, we will call for the outright upset by a solid group of 5 team.

**MICHIGAN by 42 over Smu** - The last/only prior mtg took place in 1963. SMU last ply'd a B10 foe in 1995, a 42-0 loss at Wisconsin. We won our Friday night Marquee LW on the UNDER in the SMU/TCU matchup. The Ponies have struggled since HC Dykes took over in LY's bowl, getting outscored by a comb'd 139-45 in his 3 gms at the helm. Dykes is known for his 'air raid' OFF, however he hired OC Lashlee for a more balanced attack & SMU is avg just 68 rush ypg. UM was able to bully in-state rival WM LW, dominating in all 3 phases while finishing w/a 451-208 yd edge. QB Patterson had a solid home debut throwing 3 td's & RB Higdon ran for 156 (12.0). SMU is 8-13 ATS vs non-conf foes, is leaving the state of Texas for the 1st time TY & has their conference opener vs Navy on deck. The Wolves also have their B10 opener on deck, but their physical style gives them a sizable advantage here and UM will get the blowout victory.

**APPALACHIAN ST by 21 over Southern Miss** - App St HC Scott Satterfield is 25-5 SU at home and this is the home opener and are off of a big 45-9 road win at Charlotte. Last year App St won their home games by an avg score of 41-18 and are 3-1 ATS in home openers since joining the FBS. This is the first road game for an inexp'd SMiss team that returns just 9 starters (#108 in experience) as they lost their top RB, their top 2 WR's and return just 4 str's on defense from last ssn and are off of a 21-20 upset home loss to ULM where the Golden Eagles outgained ULM 436-354, but committed 4 TO's which ended up costing them. App St has a new starter at QB they are breaking in, but sophomore Zac Thomas did not look phased in their near upset of Penn St week 1 and was a perfect 14-14 throwing the ball for 295 yds & 3 td's at Charlotte. App St will continue their strong start in front of their home fans.

**WISCONSIN by 17 over BYU** - UW dominated this game LY in the altitude, covering by over 2 td's. However, BYU QB Mangum was inj'd & DNP & is back under center TY. The Badgers dominated NM LW, finishing w/a 568-211 yd edge as Heisman hopeful RB Jonathan Taylor had a car high 253 (7.7) rush yds (however lost another fumble). BYU scored a td w/51 left LW to trim the deficit to 3, but failed to convert the onside kick. While improved, this marks their 2nd away game in 3 weeks and 3rd straight P5 conference foe. That being said, UW does have a huge game on deck in their B10 opener at Iowa which will likely have division ramifications. The Badgers are 5-13 ATS in their F3 home games (0-2 as a HF TY) while BYU is 4-0 ATS away from Provo & 18-5 as an AD including an outright win in their opener at AZ. We'll call for BYU to keep this game closer than expected.

**MINNESOTA by 10 over Miami Oh** - The last meeting between these schools took place in 2011, but MN HC Fleck saw them in '14-'15 while the HC at WM & won both by a comb'd 76-23 score (1-1 ATS). Did you call the Northcoast Comp line Saturday at 1-347-677-1700? If so you picked up a free winner on the UNDER in the Gophers 21-14 win over Fresno St LW. The win could be costly, however as RB Rodney Smith was inj'd after just 1 carry (CS). True frosh Bryce Williams took over with 25 carries (just 3.5 ypc). Trailing by 1, true frosh QB Zack Annexstad led a 74/10pl td drive w/3:28 remaining & DB Antoine Winfield sealed it w/an int in the EZ w/1:24 left on 1&GL. Speaking of winning Totals, we want a perfect 3-0 LW on our LPS plays including a 3★ winner on the UNDER

in Miami's 21-0 loss vs arch rival Cincy. MN does have their B10 opener on deck, while Miami is travelling in B2B weeks with their MAC opener on deck. Miami is 13-7 as an AD, while MN is 5-11 as a HF. We'll call for MN to win by DD's.

**AUBURN by 14 over LSU** - The home team is 16-2 SU/13-4-1 ATS in this series. Auburn is out for revenge after blowing a 20-0 lead last year in Death Valley, resulting in a 23-20 (-7) loss. LSU was dominant in their ssn opening win over Miami, but they were actually outgained in that contest 342-296 and through two games QB Burrow has completed just 48% and now they face the vaunted Auburn D that has 7 starters back from LY and has allowed just 302 ypg with 9 sacks through their F/2 games. Aub averages 494 ypg on OFF incl 288 (5.5) rush ypg. LSU's LB depth has been tested early this season with K'lavon Chaisson for the season. UA beat both Georgia and Alabama at home last year and we will call for the home team to continue their dominance of this series.

**† Usf by 9 over Illinois** - This game is being played at Soldier Field, home of the NFL Bears, so it's essentially a home game for the Illini. IL HC Smith is familiar with this venue, as he was the Bears HC for 9Y. After surviving vs Kent St in their opener, IL showed slight improvement LW vs FCS Western Illinois, however st'g QB AJ Bush was inj'd (CS) leaving the ball in the hands of true frosh MJ Rivers (Bkp Cam Thomas transferred after not being named the str' in fall camp). Making matters worse for IL is after losing WR Mike Dudek wk 1, true frosh WR Edwin Carter stepped up w/2 td's LW, but he was also inj'd after his 2nd td. USF enters off a misleading final as they were outgd 595-426 by GT in their 11 pt win, benefitting from 2 KOR td's & an 18 yd td 'drive' following a TO. IL is on just a 5-13 overall ATS run vs FBS foes, while USF is on a 24-13 overall ATS run.

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 21 over Central Michigan** - NIU has struggled vs CM losing 4 straight including a 31-24 loss last year after leading 17-0 at HT. Both teams come in 0-2 and are off losses to Power 5 teams but much different P5 mtgs. NIU lost 17-6 as an 11 pt HD, to a Utah team that is expected to compete for the Pac12 South. They only trailed 7-6 with 6:51 left before allowing a FG & a 40 yd IR td. CM is off a 31-7 loss as a 3<sup>rd</sup> pt HF over a weak Kansas team that is projected to again finish at the bottom of the Big 12. CM was only outgained 361-280 but self destructed with 6 TO's & 0 TA's. NIU is a much more experienced team (#40-#122) and has the edges on offense (#94-#117) & defense (#54-#89). We look for MAC West favorite NIU to end both their losing streaks, overall and to CM in a major way.

**CLEMSON by 34 over Georgia Southern** - First meeting. This was creative scheduling for Clemson as they get to use this game as prep for Georgia Tech's option next week. In their L/4 mtgs vs option teams, Clemson has held 4 those offenses to 200 ypg. This is a sandwich game for Clemson, coming off a closer than expected 28-26 (-12) win at Texas A&M where they were actually outgained 501-413. Georgia Southern has gotten back to their option roots under new HC Lunsford and the results have been impressive as they've rushed for 327 (5.8) ypg. Unfortunately the Tigers D won't take it easy on them as they've allowed just 94 (2.2) rush ypg. HC Swinney is just 12-19 when favored by 20+ pts and with the Tigers off an emotional win, we will call for GS to keep it closer than expected.

**New Mexico by 14 over NEW MEXICO ST** - 109th Rio Grande Rivalry. New Mexico ST has won the L2Y but by just 1 in '16 & just 2 LY as they almost blew a 30-5 4Q lead stopping the would be tying 2 pt conv with 1:11 left. While NMST return 15 starters their staring QB & top RB and the offense has struggled mightily TY as in their 3 losses TY they have been outscored by a combined 137-30 and are 0-3 SU & ATS. NM is 1-1 SU & ATS TY in their SU win they allowed 30 pt to a weaker FCS team and their ATS cover was last week as a 35 pt AD to Wisconsin (lost 45-14). While NMST still has a slight edge on defense (#92-#113), NM has a bigger offensive edge (#88-#124) and after back-to-back heartbreaking losses in the rivalry, should be able to take advantage of NMST's struggles TY with the line opening at less than a TD will look to take advantage of the early line here. NM st'g QB Tuoti is expected to miss this game (conc), but bkp QB Jones (PS#21) was orig at Tenn.

**FLORIDA by 17 over Colorado St** - 1st meeting. CSU HC Bobo was a QB and later OC at Georgia from '07-'14 so he will be plenty motivated in the 'Swamp'. Florida saw their 31Y win streak over Kentucky ended last week in a 27-16 (-13) home loss. CSU is playing their 2nd straight vs an SEC foe after shocking Arkansas last week by coming back from a 18 pt deficit in the 2H to win 34-27 (+13), as the elevation seemed to get to the Razorbacks in the 4Q. Rams' QB Carta-Samuels threw for 389 yds. UF has 19 starters back from last year's team and will be plenty motivated after their disappointing loss. Still, the Gators OFF still hasn't performed up to expectations and with CSU on a 7-0 run as an AD, we'll back the Rams to keep this game closer than expected.

**TEXAS TECH by 4 over Houston** - TT is on a 7-1 SU run in this series between in-state rivals. UH is in revenge mode after having their nation leading 16 home game win streak snapped LY. Our top rated LPS totals play has won 12 in a row dating back to LY! We will be releasing our Totals GOM this Saturday so be sure to take advantage of our weekly pkg specials on the back page of this newsletter! The UNDER was the pick LW in the UH vs AZ game, an easy winner as the Cougars had a shutout in the 1H and breezed thru the 2H. TT followed up their opening loss vs Ole Miss by scoring 77 pts in a shutout win over FCS Lamar. The Red Raiders set a modern day schl record w/7 rush td's! QB McLane Carter sat out after an ankle inj in the opener, but is expected to return here. There's no line at presstime.

We're 2 for 2 picking BSU games TY after winning a 3H LPS play in their opening blowout win over Troy, we followed up by winning a 3H LPS totals play on the OVER in their blowout over UConn LW (Totals a perfect 3-0 LW, 5-1 TY & Totals GOM goes weekend. Call the office at 1-800-654-3448 or use the NorthCoast store at ncsports.com to get on board this weekend!). New OSU st'g QB Taylor Cornelius is completing 67% w/a 6-3 ratio, but BSU has 10 str's back on D. The Bronco's are 5-2 as an AD, 34-19 ATS vs non conf & already have a win on the road TY. We'll call for BSU to pull off the outright upset and continue their quest at a NY6 Bowl bid.

**KANSAS ST by 26 over Utsa** - This is KSU's 3rd straight home game, the 1st time they've been this role s/14. The 'Cats enter off a disappointing showing LW, a rare embarrassing home loss to a ranked Miss ST squad. The 2 QB system of Skylar Thompson & Alex Delton hasn't fared well so far in 2018. UTSA entered the ssn as 1 of the least exp'd in the nation & it has certainly shown as the Roadrunners are getting out'd by 261 ypg while avg just 238 ypg on OFF & all'g nearly 500 ypg. After barely surviving FCS South Dakota in week 1 and their poor showing LW, we expect a Bill Snyder ch'd team to show a better effort this week and gain some confidence with their B12 opener at WV on deck. KSU is 6-3 ATS vs non conf foes & despite UTSA being 12-3 ATS on the road vs non-conf foes, we will call for the 'Cats to get their momentum back.

**ARKANSAS by 6 over North Texas** - Ark looks to avoid a 2nd straight loss to a G5 school. The Razorbacks led CSU 27-9 a week ago but the elevation seemed to get to them in the 4Q as they surrendered 25 unanswered to lose 34-27 (-13). NT is led by QB Mason Fine who has thrown for over 400 yds in each of the F/2 (72%, 7-1). This is a big step up in competition for NT, who has dominated their F/2 by beating SMU & Incarnate Word. Now they face an angry SEC squad and the Mean Green haven't been 3-0 to start a ssn since 1989 when they were in the FCS. HC Morris needs to settle their QB situation. Ty Storey started last week but it was Cole Kelley who threw both their td passes. Ark is 3-7 as a favorite. NT is 1-4 ATS in road openers and 0-17 when their road opener is at a P5 school. The Mean Green are 8-16 as an AD.

**OREGON by 48 over San Jose St** - This is Oregon's 3rd straight home gm and have rolled their first 2 foes by a combined score of 120-34, while San Jose St is off to an 0-2 start (567 ypg all'd in F/2 gms), incl a loss to FCS UC Davis in week 1. Oregon won their 6 home games last year by 31 ppg and have won the first two this ssn by 41 ppg. San Jose lost their road games by 32 ppg in '17 and are on their 2nd straight road game vs Pac-12 foe (lost 31-0 to Washington St, gained just 109 td yds). San Jose St is just also 5-17 ATS as a road dog the past 4 ssn's. The Ducks do have a big game the next week at home against Stanford, but were 2-0 last ssn as a 20+ point favorite and should have no problems in this game against the Spartans.

**Eastern Michigan by 3 over BUFFALO** - This is a meeting of 2 very similar teams. Both opened the season with 34+ pt wins over FCS foes and both pulled outright upsets last week on late scores. Buffalo scored a td with :59 left to beat Temple 36-29 as a 4' pt AD & EM scored a final play FG wot beat Purdue 20-19 as a 16' pt AD. The Bulls are led by QB Jackson, who after missing time LY with injury has started strong averaging 232 ypg with an impressive 9-1 ratio. EM is led by Iowa transfer QB Wiegiers, who is averaging 275 ypg with a 3-1 ratio, while Buffalo has the offensive edge (#81-#102), EM has the defensive edge (#77-#101). We cannot ignore the fact that EM is 13-2 ATS away & 12-1 as an AD and will call for another outright upset on the road.

**NEVADA by 4 over Oregon St** - These two teams are close experience wise (NEV #67, OSU #74) but Nevada is in the 2nd year of HC Jay Norvell and has a much stronger (and larger) defense than a year ago. The Wolf Pack are off of a 41-10 loss at Vanderbilt, but trailed just 17-10 at HT. Oregon St is 1-1, but that win came vs an FCS school. Norvell is 4-1 ATS at home vs FBS teams. Oregon St is 39-27 all-time against MW foes including a perfect 3-0 mark against Nevada, but the Beavers have lost their last 20 road gms SU (5-14-1 ATS in that same span). The Wolf Pack run the Air Raid offense and 2 weeks ago vs Ohio St the Beavers gave up 346 pass yds & 5 td's as well as 340 pass yds to FCS Southern Utah last week, so expect Nevada to attack Oregon St through the air early & often.

**Alabama by 28 over OLE MISS** - Bama is 4-9 ATS in this series but after losing B2B in '14-'15. The Tide has won the L/2 including last year's 66-3 (-28) beat down. The Rebels are proving to have one of the most explosive offenses in the country, but it will be tough sledding against the vaunted Bama D that held them to a ssn low 253 yards last year. Bama's offense has been explosive with QB Tagovailoa under center. They've put up 559 ypg in their F/2 and Tagovailoa has completed 71% (6-0 ratio). Ole Miss put up an impressive 646 yds and 76 points last week but they also gave up 629 yards incl 388 pass yds. They trailed 38-35 at half and scored the games L/31 pts. WR Brown already has 251 (16.7 ypc) and Bama's secondary was the one ? on D. Both offenses avg more than 500 ypg so this could be a candidate for our Totals GOM!

**TULSA by 3 over Arkansas St** - These teams last met in 2003 and the home team is 4-0 in this series. Ark St has lost their last 18 non conf road games SU and are 2-10 ATS s/2013 in non conf road games. Ark St is also off a physical game at Alabama, where they lost 57-7 and gave up 599 yds. Tulsa will need to rebound after a near upset of Texas last week and will look to attack in the in exp'd D-Line of Arkansas St with their strong run game that finished #14 in the FBS last ssn. Tulsa opened as a slight dog & ASU is 4-10 ATS vs non-conf foes. This game will come down to the wire & we like Tulsa to prevail at home in a close game.

**SOUTH ALABAMA by 14 over Texas St** - These SBC foes will meet for the 4th time, with the home team winning the previous 3. Both teams are about the same in terms of experience (SAla #93, Texas St #96). Texas St is in their 3rd year of HC Everett Withers, but have showed little signs of improvement thus far. The Bobcats are just 1-15 in SBC play SU the L2Y, but have managed to go 4-4 ATS on the road during that time. SAla is off to an 0-2 start under new HC Steve Campbell and are just 1-7 ATS as a favorite in SBC play the L2Y. Something will have to give in this matchup and we will lean with the Jaguars in this game as they return 13 str's and get this one at home.

**GEORGIA by 27 over Middle Tennessee** - The only previous meeting was in 2013. This is an SEC sandwich game for UGA after smoking S Caro 41-17 (-10). The Dawgs held 473-336 yd & 30-19 FD edges and built a 41-10 lead before SC scored in garbage time. The Blue Raiders put up their most points since '15 in last weeks 61-37 win over FCS UT Martin despite not having RB Tavarres Thomas (inj'd, CS). MT is 1-4 ATS when playing ranked SEC teams and have only scored 7 ppg in those. UGA is 1-7 when favored by 20+ points. With a big trip to Missouri on deck, we will call for MT to keep it within 4 scores.

**SOUTH CAROLINA by 8 over Marshall** - This is a huge sandwich game for SC, coming off a physical loss vs UGA with a road tilt at Vanderbilt on deck. While Marshall may only be 1-15 all-time vs SEC, their lone win was over SC in 1998 and they are 10-3 ATS vs P5 foes under HC Holiday. The Herd has 18 starters back incl 9 on both sides. Their D allowed just 19.9 ppg last year. SC has 14 starters back incl QB Bentley who has comp'd 68% (5-2) in his F/2. Isaiah Green has been the surprise starter for MU, and all he's done in his first 2 is throw for 275 ypg (62%, 3-1). Marshall was 6-0 as a dog last year and already owns one outright upset over Miami, OH so we will call for the Herd to keep it closer than expected.

**Missouri by 10 over PURDUE** - LY was the 1st mtg since the 1980 Liberty Bowl and Purdue dominated on the road, holding Mizzou to a ssn low 203 td yds. The Boilermakers were led by a dominant D LY, but TY with only 4 str's back on that side of the ball have needed to rely more on their OFF. Unfortunately, PU hasn't found a consistent signal caller as neither starter from LY, Sindelar or Blough have been able to take over the job on a full time basis. After missing a 38 yd fg that would have put them ahead by 5, PU all'd EM to drive 72/15p and hit the GW 24 yd fg w/no time left. Mizzou meanwhile, continued their domination on non P5 tms, beating WY by nearly 4 td's with QB Andrew Lock throwing for nearly 400 yds with a 4-0 ratio. Lock will benefit again from playing an in exp'd D and will pad his stats prior to entering SEC play.

**NORTHWESTERN by 21 over Akron** - First meeting. NW is using a 2 QB system as NFL prospect Clayton Thorson continues to recover from an ACL inj suffered in LY's bowl game. The 'Cats enter off a misleading home loss vs Duke LW by 2 td's despite finishing w/23-14 FD & 381-301 yd edges. After having their opener at Nebraska cancelled due to weather, Akron returned home to beat FCS Morgan St with ease LW. They still had to travel 2 wks ago so this will be their 2nd road trip in the L3W. NW has a bye on deck and should be able to fix any issues they are having on OFF. The 'Cats are 8-4 as a HF & on a 10-3 overall ATS run, while the Zips are 4-9 ATS vs non-conf FBS foes. We'll call for NW to get back on track with a win by 3 td's.

**MISSISSIPPI ST by 35 over Louisiana** - These 2 last met in 1987. Miss St is off a big road win over Kansas St and their SEC opener vs Kentucky is on deck. The Bulldogs dominated Kansas St on the ground last week in their 31-10 (-8), rushing for 384 (9.8) yds behind RB Kylin Hill (211, 12.4) and QB Nick Fitzgerald (159, 8.4). On defense, MSU allowed just 113 (3.2) rushing. UL is fresh off a bye. They've got just 11 starters back and this is new HC Napier's first career road game. HC Moorhead inherited 17 returning starters and they have a huge experience edge here (#5 vs #90). MSU is on a 10-5 ATS run while LA is 2-5 as an AD.

**TEXAS A&M by 10 over Ulm** - Despite the close loss last week vs Clemson, one has to be very impressed with HC Fisher's team and in particular, QB Kellen Mond (430 yds, 3 td's vs Clemson DI). Now they have to somehow stay motivated for a game against a ULM squad that boasts a potent offense themselves (458 ypg last year) with 17 returning starters and coming off a confidence building road win vs Southern Miss. To make matters worse for A&M, they have #1 Bama on deck. ULM was in a similar situation last year, catching Auburn in a UGA/Bama sandwich and kept it closer than expected, losing 42-14 (+37). The WarHawks were extremely fortunate last week, getting outgained 436-354 (23-13 FD deficit) and 14 pts were from TO's but we can't help but call for ULM to keep this closer than expected due to the situation.

**LOUISVILLE by 17 over Wku** - These 2 schools are separated by just 113 miles but last met in 1998. WKU led FCS Maine last week 21-0 but saw their lead evaporate as they all'd the next 31 points and lost 31-28 despite holding a 389-324 yard edge. QB Eckels looked solid, throwing for 347 and 3 td's. Now they face a Louisville squad off a weather affected 31-7 win over FCS Indiana St. QB Pass struggled in his second start, hitting just 8-14-97 with 1 int. The Cardinals have their ACC opener on deck at Virginia but they will look to get their struggling offense going here. WKU was 1-5 ATS on the road last year but will be hungry to atone for the unexpected loss last week. We'll back WKU entering off a loss to an FCS school to stay within the line this week.

**TEXAS by 4 over Usc** - USC was over a 2 td favorite LY, but needed a 31 yd fg to send the game into OT before winning it in the extra stanza. TX enters this matchup as the more exp'd squad. That exp was needed after getting upset a 2nd straight ssn by MD, the 'Horns responded with a win over Tulsa, scoring the game-deciding td w/6:13 left & running out the final 4:53. There is no 2 QB system TY as Sam Ehlinger is the clear cut starter. We went against USC LW, winning a 4★ on these pages as well as a 3★ LPS on Saturday in their loss on the Farm at Stanford. This will be their 2nd straight away game & they may be without true frosh st'g QB JT Daniels (CS). The Trojans are 10-21 ATS away and we'll call for Texas to win by just over a fg.

**† Ohio St by 17 over Tcu** - This game is being played at 'Jerry's World' in Arlington, home of the NFL Cowboys. The last meeting took place in 1973. We won our Friday night Marquee LW on the UNDER in the TCU/SMU game. After a slow start (possibly looking ahead) trailing 9-0 2Q, TCU went on a 42-3 run to close out the 'Battle for the Iron Skillet', finishing w/a 393-242 yd edge. Meanwhile, we hope you've taken advantage of our B10 POW each of the F/2 wks as we've went with the Buckeyes both times which have resulted in 2 of the easiest covers you will ever see. New st'g QB Dwayne Haskins has a 9-1 ratio in his 1st 2 career starts as OSU is outscoring their foes by a 65-17 MOV & outgaining them 650-263! While OSU is on the road for the 1st time, Buckeye Nation travels extremely well & should still have the crowd edge. TCU isn't as exp'd as prior years and OSU is a legit Nat'l Title contender. The Buckeyes have covered 4 straight games, while the Horned Frogs are on a 10-16 overall ATS run.

**Washington by 9 over UTAH** - Following a close defeat to Auburn in Wk 1 of the ssn, the Huskies had no problem getting back on track LW against FCS foe North Dakota in the 42 pt victory (632-262 yd edge). They now journey to SLC to take on a Utes squad that they've owned in their recent meetings with a 10-1 SU mark including a narrow escape a year ago in Seattle (scored 10 pts in the final :58 to get the 33-30 victory). Utah returns home following a low-scoring affair at Northern Illinois where they needed a late FG and 40 yd IR TD to get the 17-6 win (354-228 yd edge). While the Utes are a solid 6-3 ATS as a HD and have a bye on deck heading into this matchup, the Huskies recent series success and 9-4 ATS mark as P12 away chalk will have us leaning with the visitor.

**Fresno St by 3 over UCLA** - The Bulldogs have delivered wins at the Rose Bowl vs UCLA in each of their past 2 trips ('03 & '08). UCLA is off to an 0-2 start under new HC Chip Kelley and are now leaning on true freshman QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson to lead the offense. UCLA did go 6-0 at home last ssn, but won those games by an avg of just 11 ppg. Since 2015 the Bruins are just 3-9-1 ATS against non conference foes and Fresno HC Jeff Tedford is 4-0 as an AD here in his career (assuming this role as there's no line at presstime). The Bulldogs put up 79 pts in their week 1 win and nearly pulled the road upset last week at Minnesota. Fresno has the edge in special teams and a large advantage in experience (Fresno #24, UCLA #118) to go into the Rose Bowl and come out with a win.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ New England over JACKSONVILLE** - Rematch of LY's AFC Championship where the Patriots needed a pair of 4Q TD's to deliver the come-from-behind victory (JAX 374-344 yd edge). Following a 20-15 win LW on the road against the Giants where we cashed our Top Weekly LP Winner on the 3.5★ on the Under 42.5, the Jaguars return to JAX having failed to cover each of their L/6 home openers. The Patriots meanwhile head South having covered 10 of their past 11 contests after a 7 pt win over the Texans (389-325 yd edge). While the Jaguars will clearly have revenge on their mind, they are just 7-20 ATS as a NDIV HD (RB Fournette ? w/hamstring). On the flip side of the equation is a NE squad that's embraced their role as a NDIV AF with an outstanding 9-1 ATS mark. The smart money will be on the visitor getting the job done here.

**FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 10**

**3★ ATLANTA over Carolina** - After a dominating def effort LW against the Cowboys (3★ LP Winner) where they held DAL to just 16 FD's, 232 yds & 8 pts, CAR heads to ATL where they've dropped 3 consec SU & ATS by 11 ppg. While the Falcons do get the advantage of a home matchup with extra rest, their offense delivered a subpar performance LW in PHI (just 12 pts & 299 yds) where we won an easy Marquee Winner on the Under 44.5. If ATL is to fix those issues, they will have to be much more balanced as their contest against PHI saw them pass on 70% of their plays. With CAR heading in with some inj concerns on offense and having covered just 3 of their past 12 regular ssn NFC South matchups, we'll call for ATL to get back on track here as they're on a 9-1 ATS run in home openers.

**FORECAST: ATLANTA by 10**

## OTHER SELECTION

**2★ Minnesota over GREEN BAY** - Following the first series sweep of the Packers since the 2009 season, the Vikings head to Green Bay (16-0 win there LY) after getting past the 49ers and earning a 3★ LP Winner in the process (MIN +3 TO's). The Packers meanwhile overcame a 17-0 HT deficit (2nd largest comeback in Lambeau history) and an early injury to QB Rodgers (returned in 2H to throw 3 TD's) in the 24-23 victory. Rodgers now faces the team that forced him out of 9 of the final 10 in '17 with a broken collarbone. While revenge will clearly be on the mind of the veteran signal caller in this one, keep in mind that the Vikings come in on an outstanding 11-1 ATS run. We'll go ahead and call for the mild upset here as MIN appears to be one of the strongest teams in the NFL.

**FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 7**

## OTHER PLAYS

**Baltimore at CINCINNATI - Thursday** - Following a 31-27 defeat in LY's ssn finale that saw BAL miss out on the final playoff spot in the AFC, the Ravens head to CIN seeking legitimate revenge against a Bengals squad that's done relatively well in the recent series history with a 6-2 SU/ATS mark. The Ravens had no issue disposing of the Bills LW at home (3★ Newsletter Winner) behind a suffocating defense that allowed just 10 FD's and 153 yds in the 44 pt win. The Bengals meanwhile earned a comeback win LW against the Colts (snapped 8-gm losing streak in IND) with 17 unanswered pts in the 4Q (CIN outgained 380-330). While BAL is on a 7-3 ATS run in road openers, it will be interesting to see if CIN can rekindle some of LY's late game magic in their only Sept home matchup. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**WASHINGTON by 7 over Indianapolis** - While the Redskins return to D.C. following an 18 pt win against the Cardinals in the desert (29-14 FD and 429-213 yd edges), their success as a HF has been lacking as of late with just a 1-5 ATS mark. The Colts meanwhile suffered a late collapse LW at home against the Bengals (outscored 17-0 in 4Q) in the return of Andrew Luck (39-53-319 & 2-1 ratio). The scheduling edge in this one clearly goes to the Redskins as they have another home matchup on the calendar next week followed by an early bye. The Colts on the other hand have a rough upcoming slate to go through with a trip to PHI on deck followed by meetings with HOU and NE. While IND has gone a solid 20-11 ATS against the NFC, they are also just 2-6 ATS in road openers. WAS gets the TD edge here with much more talent on both sides of the ball.

**LA Chargers by 10 over BUFFALO** - After a massive 44 pt defeat LW in Baltimore (3★ Newsletter Winner on the Ravens) where QB Peterman was held to just 5-18 for 24 yds and 2 int before being replaced late for rookie Allen (6-15 for 74 yds), the Bills head back to Buffalo where they've had some recent success in home openers with a 5-1 ATS mark. Despite massive edges in both FD's (33-19) and yds (541-362), the Chargers saw a pair of TO's and an early ST's error (91 yd PR TD) result in the Chiefs claiming a 10 pt upset win. In LY's matchup in LA, QB Peterman's first career start didn't go as planned for the Bills as he was pulled at the half following 5 int's over the first 2 quarters (54-24 LAC win). With the Chargers having a 4-1-1 ATS mark in road openers and the Bills clearly not the same team that earned a playoff berth a year ago, we'll go ahead and call for the visitor to get the job done in this one.

**Houston by 7 over TENNESSEE** - Following a Wk 1 matchup in MIA that lasted over 7 hours due to a pair of weather delays, the Titans' return to Nashville with some major injury concerns on the offensive side of the ball as QB Mariota (elbow), TE Walker (ankle) and LT Lewan (concussion) all exited in Wk 1. While the Texans did see the healthy return of QB Watson LW in Foxboro (216 tll yds, 1 TD), his effort wasn't enough to get HOU get past the mighty Patriots as they jumped out to a 21-6 HT lead en route to the 7 pt win (NE 389-325 yd edge). Despite a current 0-6 ATS run dating back to LY, the Texans are getting the nod in this one as the previously mentioned injuries for the Titans have them in an extremely tough spot.

**PITTSBURGH by 10 over Kansas City** - After a dismal performance LW in CLE where they coughed up the ball on 6 occasions but still wound up in a 21-21 tie (PIT 472-327), the Steelers return home to take on a Chiefs squad that they've done extremely well against this decade with a 6-1 SU mark (6 pt avg MOV). The Patrick Mahomes era got off to an outstanding start LW in LA as the Chiefs earned the 10 pt upset victory (256 pass yds & 4 TD). Although KC does have their first matchup in Arrowhead on deck, their 3-7 ATS run as a NDIV AD doesn't bode well here as the Steelers have covered 6 of their past 8 home openers while also going 9-4 ATS as a NDIV HF.

**NY JETS by 3 over Miami** - Following a 7 pt win LW at home against the Titans where QB Tannehill threw for 230 yds & 2 TD in his return from inj, the Dolphins head North to take on a Jets squad who has come out victorious in 2 of the L/3 home matchups in this series including a 20-6 win a year ago as nearly a TD underdog. While the Jets are 5-1 ATS in DIV HG's, they do enter Wk 2 on short rest after a MNF trip to DET. This will mark rookie QB Darnold's first start in front of the home crowd with the Jets having covered 5 of their L/6 in home openers. With the Dolphins a porous 4-14 ATS in DIV AG's, we'll go ahead and give a small lean with the home squad in this one.

**Philadelphia by 6 over TAMPA BAY** - Following a performance where they did just enough to escape with a 6 pt win last Thur against the Falcons (299-232 yd deficit), the Eagles head South boasting a solid 4-1 ATS run in road openers. The Bucs meanwhile got off to an outstanding start LW in the Superdome with bkp QB Fitzpatrick (Winston susp for F/3 gms) throwing for 417 yds (5 tll TD) in the 8 pt victory as a 10 pt dog (529-475 yd edge). With starting QB Wentz also likely out of the starting lineup once again for the Eagles, it will be up to Super Bowl MVP Foles (117 yds, 56%, 0-1 LW vs ATL) to help PHI improve upon their solid 10-3-1 ATS streak against a Bucs squad that comes in with some renewed confidence.

**NEW ORLEANS by 10 over Cleveland** - While the Browns had plenty of chances to earn their first win in 18 tries (6-1 TO edge), a blocked FG attempt late in OT saw the game end in a 21-21 tie (PIT 472-327 yd edge). CLE now heads to the "Big Easy" with just a 2-6 ATS mark in road openers. The

Saints defense had no answer for the TB offense a week ago in the Superdome with the Bucs putting up 48 pts and 529 yds in the outright upset victory. While the Saints have covered just 2 of their past 8 as a NDIV HF, we'll be siding with them in this one as CLE is just 8-16 ATS as an AD, have failed to cover 11 of their past 12 against the NFC and have a short week on deck with a winnable Thur night battle against the Jets.

**LA RAMS by 7 over Arizona** - Only road contest in the first month of the ssn for the Cardinals as they head to LA following an 18 pt loss LW against the Redskins where they were held to just 6 pts and 212 yds. The Rams return home on short rest after a MNF battle in the "Black Hole" against the Raiders having gone just 3-15 ATS as a DIV HF. LY the Rams delivered a pair of victories against the Cardinals including a 33-0 shutout across the pond in London. Despite having a loaded roster from front to back, this appears to be the Rams' easiest contest over the first month with visits from the Chargers and Vikings on deck. While we'll go ahead and call for the Cardinals to drop their first meeting of the season, a TD lean is all that we can give in this one as not only have the Cardinals covered 8 of their past 10 road openers, but they're also 11-4 ATS in their trips inside of the NFC West. **SAF FRANCISCO by 7 over Detroit** - After a rough outing LW in MIN where they were forced into 4 TO's in the 8 pt defeat, the 49ers return to Santa Clara with an outstanding 7-2 ATS mark in home openers. The Lions meanwhile enter Wk 2 following a MNF matchup against the Jets. In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Lions were able to snap a 9-gm losing streak that dated back to 1996. While SF is just 3-9 ATS as a HF, this is a tough spot for the Lions (5-11 ATS as a NDIV AD) having to travel out West on a short week.

**DENVER by 7 over Oakland** - Despite 3 int's in his debut with the Broncos, QB Keenum's overall performance was a relatively successful one as he also threw for 329 yds and 3 TD's in the 3 pt win. The Raiders meanwhile head to DEN on short rest following their MNF meeting with the Rams. In their solid start of a year ago, the Broncos picked up a 16-10 victory over the Raiders to move their current home streak to 5-1 SU/ATS (17 pt avg MOV) against the "Silver and Black." With OAK being the oldest team in the entire NFL and breaking in a new coaching staff, we'll go ahead and back the home squad in this one as the Raiders have now dropped 4 in a row ATS as a DIV AD.

**NY Giants at DALLAS - SNF** - Following a 5 pt home loss to the Jaguars where they finished with a 324-305 yd edge (3.5★ Top Play LP Winner on Under 42.5), the Giants head South to take on the Cowboys in their road opener for the 5th time in the L/6 yrs (1-4 SU, 5 pt avg defeat). The Cowboys had some major issues LW in Charlotte against the Panthers (3★ LP Winner on CAR) as their offense was held to just 8 pts and 232 yds. This is a tough matchup to forecast here as neither have done well in this situation with the Giants just 3-7 ATS in DIV AG's and DAL having covered just 7 of their past 25 opportunities as an NFC East HF. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

**Seattle at CHICAGO - MNF** - After a SNF matchup against the Packers where they were unable to hold onto a dominating 17-0 HT lead in Lambeau, the Bears are in primetime for the 2nd consecutive week. The Seahawks head East following a 3 pt loss in DEN (outgained 470-306). In their most recent matchup back in '15, the Seahawks' defense allowed just 146 tll yds in the 26-0 win. This will be an interesting situation for both squads here as while SEA is just 9-16 ATS as a NDIV AD, the Bears are much more comfortable when being listed as a HD as they've covered just 1 of their past 7 as a HF.
