## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Florida St over Boise St** - 1st meeting. This game is being held at TIAA Bank Field, home of the Jacksonville Jaguars. Willie Taggart's needs to show improvement in year 2 as HC. The 'Noles have lost 2 straight ssn openers, putting up a combined 10 pts. Boise St has won their ssn opener 4 straight years but they had lost the 3 prior to that. FSU returns 16 starters and they have 2 experienced QB's in James Blackman and Wisconsin transfer Alex Hornibrook. Bst gets 13 starters back but will need to replace their QB (MW OFF POY), RB (#3DC) and top 2 WR's (Both All-MW). They face an FSU defense with 8 starters back including all 4 DB's. This is a tough spot to break in a new QB. FSU has talent, experience (#60 vs #81) and location edges so we will give the 'Noles a strong lean and call for HC Taggart to get '19 rolling the right way. **FORECAST: Florida St by 17**

**3★ USF (+) over Wisconsin** - The only prior meeting was in Madison in '14, a 27-10 (-33) UW win. The Badgers did play in this venue in the Outback Bowl following the '14 season. This is UW's first true road season opener s/10, while USF is hosting an FBS member in their opener for the first time s/11. The Bulls have the experience edge entering the '19 campaign with 15 starters back including 9 on OFF with QB Blake Barnett, RB Jordan Cronkrite, and WR Randall St Felix returning. UW has 12 starters back, but must replace their QB, 4 starting OL, and 4 of their top 5 tacklers including their top 2. Sure the Badgers avg 273 (6.2) rush ypg LY and still have RB Jonathan Taylor while USF allowed 248 (5.1) rush ypg, but USF returns 3 starters on the DL and the new OL that UW is breaking in could see some fatigue in the Florida heat. The Badgers are 1-4 ATS in reg ssn non-conf games and 3-6 ATS in August, while the Bulls are 14-9 ATS at home. We'll call for USF to keep this game closer than expected. **FORECAST: Wisconsin by 6**

**3★ Toledo (+) over KENTUCKY** - First meeting. Kentucky has struggled recently in openers vs Group of 5 opponents. Last year they trailed Central Mich 17-7 in the 2Q and only led 21-20 at half. In '17 they were outgained by S Miss by 107 yards in a 7 point win. In '16 they blew a 35-17 halftime lead at home vs S Miss, allowing 27 unanswered. In '15 they needed a GW 1d with 1:03 to hold off Louisiana. Now the Wildcats face a hungry Toledo team off their lowest win total (7) in 5 seasons. The Rockets have 11 starters back including 2 experienced QB's, Guadagni and Peters. Kentucky brings back 10 starters including just 4 on defense. They replace their entire secondary and lose 5 of their top 7 tacklers. Kentucky is just 0-7 ATS in ssn openers vs FBS teams and they've failed to cover their last 10 as a HF! Based on all of this, we can't help but back the underdog. **FORECAST: KENTUCKY by 5**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ RUTGERS by 23 over UMass** - These programs haven't met on the gridiron since 1978. UMass is the least experienced team in the nation entering 2019. The Minutemen have just 8 starters back and must replace their starting QB, RB, and #2DC WR along with their top 2 tacklers. UMass also has a first year HC in Walt Bell and figure to go through some growing pains. RU has 13 starters back including 8 on OFF led by QB Artur Sitkowski, RB Raheem Blackshear and WR Bo Melton. The Scarlet Knights had lost 3 straight home openers by 22 ppg until beating TXST by 28 LY. Since joining the FBS ranks in 2012, UMass has lost all 7 of their road openers by an avg of 26 ppg. RU ended last year on a 5-0 overall ATS run, while UMass is 1-4 as a DD dog, 1-4 ATS in their FBS opener, and 2-5 ATS away. This is an extremely important season for RU HC Chris Ash and we'll call for the Scarlet Knights to get the blowout win. **FORECAST: RUTGERS by 23**

**2★ Missouri by 24 over WYOMING** - Missouri makes their first trip to Laramie. The Tigers are playing with an "us against the world" attitude after a 1 year bowl ban was passed down. Clemson transfer Kelly Bryant (12-2 as starter) steps in for departed QB Lock and the Tigers also return 13 starters. They have 3 All-SEC caliber Oline back from a unit that allowed just 13 sacks each of the last 2 years and average 330 lbs per man. WY only has 1 Dline starter returning from a unit that averages just 260 lbs. The Cowboys have played 7 Power 5 teams under HC Bohl, going 0-7 SU/2-5 ATS and losing by an avg of 33.4 ppg with the closest loss being 17 points. HC Odom is 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS vs non-P5 foes including a 40-13 (-19) home win over the Cowboys last year. With extra time to prep for the altitude, we will lean with the Power 5 team that has a habit of bullying weaker opponents. **FORECAST: Missouri by 24**

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY AUGUST 29TH

**Ucla by 1 over CINCINNATI** - UCLA is in revenge mode after losing outright at home last year in Chip Kelly's debut despite being more than 2 td chalk. The Bruins have the experience edge with 19 starters back including QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson, RB Joshua Kelly, and 6 of their top 7 leading tacklers. Cincy has 14 starters back, led by QB Desmond Ridder, RB Michael Warren, and 3 of their top 4 tacklers back. The 'Cats had to replace four OL starters LY and still avg 239 (5.2) rush ypg. This year they lose 3 OL starters. The Bruins allowed 199 (4.6) rush ypg LY and while they return all 4 DL starters, still figure to have trouble slowing Warren down. Cincy is 7-15 ATS vs non-conf foes, but UCLA is 4-13 in the same role. Cincy 6-9 as home chalk, but UCLA is 3-5 as an AD. Cincy is 5-11 ATS hosting FBS foes, but UCLA is 4-13 ATS vs non-conf. Cincy HC Fickell is just 1-9 as single digit chalk, but UCLA is 4-9 ATS away from the Rose Bowl. Tough to side with either school in a game that will likely go down to the wire.

**CLEMSON by 42 Georgia Tech** - Last year we used Clemson as our Free September 5★ against Georgia Tech and the Tigers delivered a super easy winner, leading 42-7 in the 3Q in a 49-21 (-16) win. The National Champs bring back 12 returning starters including QB Trevor Lawrence. The Tigers will need to rebuild their Dline after losing 4 NFL draft picks but they've got plenty of talent incl DE Xavier Thomas (10.5 tfl LY). GT return just 9 starters in new HC Geoff Collins' first season while they transition away from the triple option. The Jackets must replace their entire Dline which will be an issue against Clemson who returns 4 Olines that started 7 games or more, and last year's Walker Award Finalist RB Etienne. The Tigers won their last 10 games (8-1-1 ATS run) by 36 ppg last season and we expect similar results against a team playing their first game after a major scheme change. HC Collins team's have been notorious slow starters (0-4 ATS first 2 weeks L2Y). Clemson does have A&M on deck but this should get out of hand early.

**TULANE by 3 over FIU** - FIU won the only prior meeting, 23-10 (+13) in Miami. Tulane is opening the season on a Thursday for the sixth time in the L7Y, but hasn't beaten an FBS foe in their home opener since 2000 (3-6 ATS s/05). FIU is one of the most experienced teams in the nation for '19 with 16 starters back, including QB James Morgan, RB Napoleon Maxwell, and leading tackler LB Sage Lewis. Tulane counters with 13 starters back including QB Justin McMillan, RB Darius Bradwell, and WR Darnell Mooney, but does have to replace their top 2 tacklers and is breaking in a new OFF. FIU is 12-7 as an AD while Tulane is 11-19 as home chalk. FIU is on a 10-3 ATS run in the reg ssn while Tulane is on a 4-7 overall ATS run. Tough to decide on this one and we'll call for this to finish near the line.

**TEXAS A&M by 31 over Texas St** - The Aggies went 6-1 SU/ATS in College Station in HC Jimbo Fisher's first year. Texas A&M returns 11 starters from a 9 win team. The Aggies have 7 starters back on offense. QB Kellen Mond was one of the most improved QB's in '18 (3107, 57%, 24-9). Texas St avg just 19.8 ppg last year and they face an A&M defense that must replace their top 6 tkl'rs. Texas St has 19 returning starters. HC Spavital is familiar with the 12th man, having been OC at A&M in '14-'15. The Bobcats have significantly improved on defense over the last 2 years, going from 41.1 ppg to 33.6 then 27.7 last year and they've got 10 starters back. Texas St is much more experienced (#2 vs #97) and A&M does have a big trip to Clemson on deck. A&M will control the game, but we think there's value in a backdoor cover for the Bobcats.

**ARIZONA ST by 35 over Kent St** - First meeting and just the second ever time AZSt is playing a MAC member (1979 vs Toledo). AZSt has won 19 straight home openers by 32 ppg, while KSt has lost 11 straight road openers by 32 ppg. The Golden Flashes are one of the most experienced teams in the nation into the '19 season. They return 15 starters including QB Woody Barrett, RB Jo-EI Shaw, their top 3 WR's, and 4 of their top 5 tacklers. While the Sun Devils also have 15 starters back, they must replace their top 4 all-time passer and #1DC WR. Expected to fill those roles are true frosh QB Jayden Daniels (PS#6) who was IFS and WR Brandon Aiyuk, who is a 2nd year Juco. KSt allowed 241 (5.3) rush ypg away last year and AZSt does get the return of 2nd Tm AA RB Eno Benjamin, who should be able to run wild. The Golden Flashes are 16-27 ATS vs non-conf foes while the Sun Devils are 8-3 as home chalk. We'll call for AZSt to win in a blowout.

**Utah by 1 over BYU** - This is the 94th "Holy War." While BYU has lost 8 straight in the series, only once was it by more than 8 points. Utah is on a 10-4 ATS series run and is 4-0 ATS in Provo. LY in the reg ssn finale the Cougars led 27-7 late 3Q, but allowed 28 unanswered and lost 35-27 (+11). These teams are just about the same in terms of experience returning. The Utes have 14 starters back. While they return QB Tyrone Huntley, 2nd Tm P12 RB Zack Moss and their top 5 WR's, they also must replace their top 4 tacklers. BYU returns 17 starters including QB Zach Wilson and their top 3 WR's, while adding RB Ty'Son Williams as a grad transfer from SC. The Cougars are 23-11 as a dog and the dog in this series is 7-2. We can't help but feel BYU is still seething at LY's loss and while they won't exact revenge on the scoreboard, they will keep it close.

### FRIDAY AUGUST 30TH

**ARMY by 21 over Rice** - The last time these two met in '17 Army led 35-0 at half & won 49-12 (-12). Army has won 5 of their last 6 home openers incl 3 straight by 33 ppg (avg line -12). The Black Knights are off an 11 win season and have 11 returning starters (7 OFF, 4 DEF) incl QB Hopkins who topped 1,000 yds passing & rushing LY. Rice returns 12 starters from a team that won just 2 games last year. They will need to find a new starting QB to lead an offense that averaged just 18.9 ppg. The Owls get 8 of their top 12 tacklers back from a unit that allowed 36 ppg. Their Dline is smaller and quicker (no 300 lb's), and with extra time to prep for the option they should keep the game competitive. Army is 7-12 as a HF while Rice went 5-2 as an AD in HC Bloomgren's first year so we will lean with the Owls to keep it under this large line.

**WAKE FOREST by 10 over Utah St** - The home team has won both meetings in this series (1-1 ATS). The last time the Aggies traveled to the East Coast was also LTH and WF easily took care of business, 46-10 (-13). The Demon Deacons have a large experience edge here (#33 vs #124). WF brings back 12 returning starters incl a 1,000 yd rusher in Cade Carney (5.3). QB Newman is battle tested after pulling 2 outright upsets as DD Dogs plus an upset in the bowl last year. Utah St returns just 2 starters on offense but one of them is QB Jordan Love (64%, 32-6). The Aggies have 7 starters back on defense and only allowed 22.2 ppg last year. This is Gary Anderson's second stint at Utah St and during his prev stint ('09-'12) the Aggies were 14-2 as an AD. Wake has covered just one of their last 7 home games. The Demon Deacons have the experience edge and they are a Power 5 team at home, so we will call for the victory by DD's.

**MICHIGAN ST by 17 over Tulsa** - First meeting. MSU has opened on a Friday 7 of the L8Y and is 7-0 SU/1-6 ATS. Tulsa opened the season at home 3 straight years from '14-'16, but this is their 2nd time beginning on road in the L3Y. Both have plenty of experience returning, but Sparty is among the most experienced in the nation with 17 returning starters including QB Brian Lewerke, WR Cody White, RB Connor Heyward, and leading tackler LB Joe Bachie. Tulsa has 14 starters back including RB Shamari Brooks, WR Keylon Stokes, and 10 of their top 11 tacklers (incl top 3). MSU's avg OFF should be a good confidence builder for the improved Golden Hurricane D it expects to field this year. TU is 14-8 as an AD, while MSU is 0-5 as home chalk. Sparty is also 0-4 as DD chalk and 2-7 ATS at home vs non-conf foes. We'll call for MSU to win, but for Tulsa to keep it closer than expected.

**Colorado by 12 over Colorado St** - This is the 91st Rocky Mountain Showdown and 10th straight year being played at a neutral field in Denver. CU is on an 8-3-1 ATS series run. LY was the Buff's season opener while CSU had a GUB edge. CU's 45 points was its most in the series since 1996! The Buff's have the experience edge this year as their 11 returning starters include QB Steven Montez, 4th Tm AA WR Laviska Shenault, pre-ssn 1st Tm P12 LB Nate Landman, along with 6 OL that have starting experience. The Rams also have 11 starters back, but must replace their leading RB, QB, top 2 WR's as well as their top 2 tacklers! CU has had B2B 1,000 yard rushers and CSU allowed 220 (5.3) rush ypg LY. Projected starting RB Alex Fontenot should be in-line for a solid outing. The Rams are 4-10 ATS vs non-conf foes and on a 5-13 overall ATS run. We'll call for the Buff's to win their 5th in a row SU in the series, this time by nearly 2 tds.

**Purdue by 6 over NEVADA** - This is the 2nd all-time meeting and the furthest that PU has travelled for a reg ssn game since 2009. The Boilermakers had lost all 9 of their true road openers from 2008-'16, but have won B2B under HC Brohm. NV has won 14 of their last 18 home openers, but 10 were against FCS foes. The Wolfpack has lost their last two home openers against FBS foes. Neither team has much experience returning, but both feature 3rd year HC's. PU has 12 starters back including 9 on D including 4 of their top 5 tacklers (incl top 3). While the Boilermakers must replace a 3rd Tm B10 QB and their starting RB, they have experience under center in Elijah Sindelar and a dynamic playmaker in pre-ssn 1st Tm AA WR Rondale Moore. NV has 11 starters back including RB Tia Tava, WR Kaleb Fossom, and leading tackler LB Gabe Sewell. PU ended LY on a 1-5 ATS run and NV enters '19 on a 5-2 ATS run. The Wolfpack are also 4-1 as a HD. We'll call for NV to keep it a tad closer than expected.

**Oklahoma ST by 21 over OREGON ST** - 1st meeting. OKSt is opening the season in a true road game for just the 2nd time in the L10Y and the first since travelling to CM and winning 24-13 (-23) in '15. OregSt is hosting an FBS team in their home opener for the first time s/2012, when they beat #13 Wisc 10-7 (+7). While the Pokes are middle of the pack experience wise entering 2019, the Beavers have 1 of the most experienced squads in the nation returning. OregSt has 16 starters back including QB Jake Luton, RB Jermar Jefferson, WR Isaiah Hodgins, as well as their top 9 tacklers! OKSt returns 12 starters and must replace their starting QB, #4DC RB, and 2 of their top 3 tacklers. They do return 1st Tm AA WR Tylan Wallace and HC Gundu has great success breaking in new QB's. OKSt is on a 4-2 ATS run while OregSt is on a 6-15 ATS run. The Pokes are 6-4 as DD chalk and the Beavers are 7-15 as a HD. We'll call for OKSt to have little trouble and win by 3 tds.

### SATURDAY AUGUST 31ST

**OHIO ST by 29 over Fau** - 1st meeting. New OSU HC Ryan Day was the interim HC for LY's 77-31 (-39) home opening win over OregSt. FAU lost their road opener at Oklahoma LY 63-14 (+20). OSU has 13 starters back and while they must replace a #1DC QB and #2 & #3DC WR's, they return 6 of their top 7 tacklers including the top 5. FAU also returns 13 starters, but must replace 2 NFL DC RB's, their leading WR, and 2 of their top 3 tacklers. CUSA Frosh POY Chris Robison is back for FAU after missing spring (Susp). The Buckeyes are 13-6 as non-conf chalk of 27+ points, while FAU is 2-7 as a DD dog. The Owls are also on just a 3-7-1 overall ATS run. Normally a team losing a HOF HC would have some growing pains, but HC Day is a consistent presence and filled in fine for the suspended Urban Meyer LY (1/2 point away from 3-0 ATS). OSU gets the Ryan Day era started with a blowout win while FAU will look to stay healthy for a much more important in-state battle next week.

**NEBRASKA by 42 over South Alabama** - The only prior meeting was here in 2015 with NU winning 48-9 (-27). After LY's original home/season opener vs Akron was cancelled due to stormy weather, the Huskers were forced to begin a week later vs Colorado and lost just their 2nd opener in the L33Y. USA has played a P5 foe in their road opener 6 times, losing 5 by an avg score of 43-14. NU is middle-of-the-road in terms of experience returning for '19. The Huskers have 13 starters back including pre-ssn 2nd Tm B10 QB Adrian Martinez, 2x 2nd Tm B10 WR JD Spielman, and leading tackler LB Mohamed Barry. USA is one of the least experienced in the nation. The Jag's also return 13 starters, but must replace their starting QB, leading WR, 4 of their top 6 tacklers including the top 2. NU was changing OFF philosophies LY and after starting 0-6 SU/2-4 ATS vs FBS foes, they ended 3-2 SU/5-0 ATS. The Huskers are on a 7-0 overall ATS run, while the Jag's are 18-33 ATS. NU is 10-4 ATS in season openers, while USA is 6-14 ATS away. Nebraska will be the total opposite of LY and starts their season off with a bang.

**NC ST by 13 over East Carolina** - These schools closed out the regular season LY in an added game after each had a game cancelled earlier in the year due to the effects of Hurricane Florence. EC had covered three straight in the series until LY's blowout loss, which was played 48 hours after the firing of Scottie Montgomery. NCSt enters '19 as one of the least experienced teams in the country with just 11 starters back including just 4 on OFF. EC returns 14 starters including QB Holton Ahlers. The Pirates have a new HC in Mike Houston, who guided James Madison to an FCS Nat'l Title in 2016. EC hasn't opened the season vs an FBS foe since 2013 and hasn't began in a true road game since 2007! The Pirates are 15-9 ATS vs non-conf foes, while NCSt is 4-6 as a HF and on a 3-6 overall ATS run. We'll call for EC to keep this game slightly closer than expected.

**ILLINOIS by 17 over Akron** - In the only prior meeting in 1996 IL hosted and won 38-7 (-27). The Illini has won 21 straight home openers by an avg of 24 ppg. Akron had dropped 24 straight road openers by 30 ppg before upsetting NW LY after their original road opener at Nebraska was cancelled due to weather. IL's 4th yr HC Lovie Smith has solid experience returning for '19 with 17 returning starters including pre-ssn 2nd Tm B10 RB Reggie Corbin, leading WR Ricky Smalling, and 6 of their top 7 tacklers. Akron counters with a 1st yr FBS HC that has just 10 returning starters and must replace their starting RB as well as 7 of their top 9 tacklers. IL is 15-28 as home chalk, but Akron is on a 3-6 overall ATS run. We'll call for the Illini to win by over 2 tds.

**Indiana by 16 over Ball St** - This game is being played at Lucas Oil Stadium, home of the NFL's Colts and the B10 Championship game. In-state rivals are meeting for the 10th time. The last time they opened the season against each other was in this very stadium (2011) and BSt pulled the outright upset 27-20 (+5). BSt is 4-1 ATS in the series, but failed to cover LY losing 38-10 (+15). IU has an experienced squad back for '19, returning 14 starters from a club that finished 5-7 LY, including RB Stevie Scott and WR's Nick Westbrook & Donavan Hale. As experienced as IU is, BSU is more so with 17 returning starters back from a 4-8 team. While the Card's have to replace their starting RB & QB, they return WR's Riley Miller and Justin Hall along with their top 7 tacklers led by LB Ray Wilborn and SS Bryce Cosby. IU is 2-4 as chalk and 3-8 ATS in season openers vs FBS foes. We'll call for BSt to keep this one slightly closer than expected.

**Mississippi St by 17 over Louisiana** - This game is being played at Mercedes-Benz Superdome in New Orleans. Miss St only brings back 11 starters including 7 on OFF but they picked up 2 big transfer additions in QB Tommy Stevens, who played under Moorhead at Penn St and WR Isaiah Zuber (Kansas St). Billy Napier did an admirable job getting the Cajuns to 7 wins and an SBC West Title in his first year. UL has 15 returning starters, though they do lose 7 of their top 15 tk'rs and must replace their starting QB. The Cajuns will need to get RB Trey Ragas going (1,181, 5.7 LY). He was held to just 49 yds in LY's 56-10 (-34) loss to the Bulldogs. Fortunately for Louisiana, all 4 Dline starters are gone from LY's Miss St D that allowed just 95 (2.9) ypg. Miss St was 5-0 as a DD Fav last year but Louisiana was 4-1-1 as an AD. The Cajuns have the experience edge (#15 vs #84) and are big dogs at a neutral site so we will take the points.

**Memphis by 1 over Ole Miss** - Ole Miss is on a 3-1-1 ATS series run. The Rebels haven't opened the season in a true road game since '13, but these schools are just 85 miles apart. Memphis has won 5 straight home openers, but the last time they hosted a P5 in their opener they lost vs Duke 28-14 (+4). Ole Miss is one of the least experienced squads entering '19 with just 13 starters back including just 3 on OFF, but did hire Rich Rodriguez as the new OC. The Rebels do however return 10 on D, led by leading tackler LB Mohamed Sanogo. Memphis has 14 starters back including QB Brady White. While White was solid LY (3296, 62.8%, 26-9) its worth noting that he completed just 53.5% with a 6-6 ratio vs the 5 FBS teams he faced with a winning record. With the bowl ban gone and the return to a full 85 scholarships, the Rebels have postseason play on their minds. Ole Miss is 15-7-1 ATS vs non-conf FBS foes, should be angry being a dog vs a G5, and will keep this closer than expected.

**Tennessee by 30 over Georgia St** - Excitement is back in Knoxville where the Vols return 16 starters including 10 on offense and they added some top notch recruits to bolster talent. Georgia St has lost all 9 meetings vs Power 5 foes by an avg score of 43-10. The Panthers covered their first 7 vs non power 5 foes but failed to cover their last 2. GSt has 14 returning starters back incl QB Dan Ellington (60%, 12-5) and they get back 9 of their top 11 tacklers. The Vols are 9-0 all-time vs SBC teams with an avg score of 43-15. Tennessee did have two lackluster efforts last year vs UTEP & Charlotte but this being the opener, we expect a full effort. Georgia St went 0-4-2 as an AD last year and the Vols have edges on all 3 phases so we have a slight lean with the chalk.

**Eastern Michigan by 7 over COASTAL CAROLINA** - First meeting. EM has won 3 of their L/4 road openers SU including B2B at Rutgers in '17 and Purdue LY. CC will have the experience edge as they return 15 starters including RB CJ Marable, 4 OL, and 4 of their top 5 tacklers. The Eagles have just 10 starters back, but QB Mike Glass would've started more than 3 games had he been healthy. EM HC Chris Creighton took over a program that hadn't won 7 games in a season since 1989, but they've achieved that twice in the L3Y! The Chanticleers allowed 278 (6.5) rush ypg at home LY and Glass is extremely mobile while RB Shaq Yann is 5-10 215 pounds. EM wasn't road chalk for 10 straight years, but has been in that role each of the L3Y. CC is 1-6-1 ATS overall, while EM is 25-10-1. The Eagles are also 16-4 ATS away and we'll call for EM to win by a td.

**South Carolina by 12 over North Carolina** - This game is being played at Bank of American Stadium in Charlotte and this is the fourth meeting in the last 7 years. SC is 3-0 SU/2-1 in recent meetings including wins in both the '13 and '15 openers. Will Muschamp was DC under Mack Brown at TX from '08-'10 and was expected to succeed him. Mack Brown inherits an inexperienced squad (#103) with 14 returning starters but major concerns at QB. The Gamecocks also have 14 returning starters but are much more experienced (#30) and have a returning 3Y starting QB in Jake Bentley (3,171, 62%, 27-14 LY). NC should be much better on defense after allowing 34.5 ppg last year. SC should also be improved on defense after being riddled with injuries last year, which led to nearly a td increase in ppg allowed (27.2). The Gamecocks have edges in all 3 phases and are more experienced while NC is 0-11 SU/4-7 ATS when opening vs a P5 foe.

**Alabama by 28 over Duke** - This game is being played at Mercedes-Benz Stadium in Atlanta. Alabama has won 17 straight openers and have covered 10 of their last 11 which includes 9 Neutral Site openers (avg MOV 24 ppg). The Tide are used to playing here, having won the '17 Nat'l Title and '18 SEC Title games here. Duke has 12 returning starters with just 4 on offense and they must replace #1 DC QB Daniel Jones (pro-style) with Quentin Harris (dual threat). The Crimson Tide also return 12 starters. Four Alabama WR's return that topped 690 yards last year. Duke has 3 returning starters in their secondary and does get '18 All-American CB Mark Gilbert (cousin of Darrelle Revis) back from injury. HC Saban has a lot of respect for HC Cutcliffe so we don't expect he will run it up and Duke is 23-6 ATS in non-conf play since 2013. We will take the points.

**Stanford by 8 over Northwestern** - NW has covered the last 3 meetings between these academic powers. The 'Cats opened the season at home 4 straight years, but have begun on the road in B2B seasons. Stanford is opening on the Farm for the 8th time in the L10Y. NW has just 12 starters back and must replace a #5DC QB and their leading WR. Stanford is even less experienced, with just 9 starters back and must replace their starting RB, top 3 WR's, and top 2 tacklers. The Cardinal do return one of the nations best QB's in KJ Costello and the 'Cats are replacing 2 DB starters from a unit that finished #85 in our PDR LY. Stanford is on a 31-21 ATS run. It's tough to play against NW as a dog, but we feel that Stanford has the edge at home (6-3 ATS run on the Farm) and wins by just over a td.

**Virginia Tech by 3 over BOSTON COLLEGE** - Virginia Tech has won their last 3 season openers (2-1 ATS). Last year they saw their 3 game series win streak end vs the Eagles. VT led 14-7 at half then put up just 32 yds in the 3Q and BC won 31-21 (-2). The Hokies are 13-2 in ACC road openers (11-4 ATS) incl LY's opener at FSU when they won 24-3. BC has lost their last 3 when opening the season with a Power 5 foe. HC Adazio will have his work cut out for him with just 9 starters back and they go from #12 to #96 in experience. Virginia Tech has 16 starters back and were very unlucky with injuries/suspensions last year. They get QB Ryan Willis back (2776, 59%, 24-9) and 8 of their top 9 tacklers are back so their defense should be vastly improved after allowing a Bud Foster era high 31 ppg. BC has covered 9 straight ACC games as a dog but we feel VT should be improved so we don't have a strong lean either way.

**Syracuse by 14 over LIBERTY** - First meeting. The Flames have won 15 of their last 16 season openers and blew out ODU 52-10 (+5) last year. Syracuse has won their last 5 season openers with 4 of those coming vs FCS foes. The Orange return 13 starters from a 10 win team. Tommy DeVito takes over at QB and they return DE's Robinson and Coleman, who both had 10 sks last year. New HC Hugh Freeze returns 15 starters and the Flames should have plenty of offensive firepower, returning QB Stephen Calvert (3,068, 55%, 21-18), and a 1,000 RB and WR. Liberty hung with Virginia last year, only trailing 31-24 in the 3Q of a 21 pt loss (+24). The Flames are 13-4 as an AD. Cuse has a tough matchup at Maryland on deck and they gave up 42 points in LY's opener vs W Mich. This should be a high scoring affair and Liberty will be hyped to host a P5 foe for the first time ever.

**ARKANSAS ST by 3 over Smu** - SMU hasn't won 3 straight season openers since winning 15 in a row from 1972-'86! The Ponies have won just 2 of their L/22 road openers. AST is hosting an FBS foe in their home opener for just the 3rd time in the L7Y and first since losing vs Toledo 31-10 (-4) in '16. This is the 4th meeting and the host is 3-0 SU/ATS. SMU has a slight experience edge entering the '19 campaign with 16 returning starters including pre-ssn 4th Tm AA WR James Proche and 3 of their top 4 tacklers (incl #1 LB Richard Moore). AST has 13 starters back including 1st Tm SBC WR Kirk Merritt, pre-ssn 2nd Tm SBC RB Marcel Murray and leading tackler NB Darreon Jackson. However, AST will likely be without HC Anderson after his wife passed away earlier this month. SMU does have an experienced signal caller as well after the addition of Texas grad transfer Shane Buechele. AST is 27-14 as home chalk, but the Pones are 8-3-1 ATS in reg ssn non-conf games. This game will go down to the wire and we'll call for the Red Wolves to win by a fg.

**MICHIGAN by 42 over Middle Tennessee** - First meeting. UM enters the 2019 season with National Title aspirations following a disappointing finish LY. The Wolve's have won 10 straight home openers by 32 ppg. MT is 6-29 SU vs P5 foes under HC Rick Stockstill, losing by an avg of 22 ppg. UM returns 13 starters including pre-ssn 1st Tm B10 QB Shea Patterson, pre-ssn 2nd Tm B10 WR Donovan Peoples-Jones, and 4 of the 5 OL. Despite having just 5 starters back on D, the DC remains Don Brown and when the Wolve's had just 1 starter on D back in '17, he led the unit to allow just 18.8 ppg! MT is among the least experienced teams in the nation for '19. The Blue Raiders return just 11 starters and must replace their career leading passer, 3 starting OL, and 4 of their top 7 tacklers. UM is 6-2 as home chalk while MT is 6-12 as a DD dog including 2-5 as a dog of 20+ points. UM erases the bad taste in their mouths from the L/2 games of '18 with a dominant blowout victory to open a promising season.

**IOWA by 25 over Miami, Oh** - IO has won all 4 meetings by an avg score of 35-17. The Hawkeyes have won 16 of their last 18 home openers, but their last loss was against fellow MAC member NIU in 2013, 30-27 (-3). Miami has lost 10 of their last 11 season openers with the lone win coming against an FCS foe. Neither team is vastly experienced entering the '19 campaign, but IO is slightly more. The Hawkeyes return 10 starters, but among those are pre-ssn 3rd Tm B10 QB Nathan Stanley and their top 3 RB's. Pre-ssn 2nd Tm AA DE AJ Epenesa anchors the D. Miami also has just 10 starters back, but among those returning are a pair of pre-ssn 1st Tm MAC honorees in WR Jack Sorenson, DT Dough Costin, and KR Maurice Thomas. IO is 24-14 as chalk and 9-5 ATS at home. Kinnick Stadium is a tough place to play for road teams and made even tougher due to the fact that this game is being played at night.

**LSU by 21 over Georgia Southern** - LSU is 13-0 in home openers, winning by an avg 33 pt MOV. The Tigers are just 3-7ATS vs non-conf foes the last 2 years. GA Southern got back to their option roots last year and improved from 2 wins to 10 wins. The Eagles only lost to Clemson 38-7 (+32) last year and are 2-2-1 ATS against P5 foes the L3Y. LSU returns 16 starters (#19 exp) including 6 of their front 7 on defense while Georgia Southern brings back 14 starters (#37 exp). LSU is 0-6 as a 20+ pt fav while GA Southern is 8-1-1 as a 20+ dog and LSU has Texas on deck so we can only give a slight lean to the Tigers.

**Georgia by 27 over VANDERBILT** - Georgia opens the season with an SEC foe for the first time since 1995. UGA has covered the last two in this series, winning by 31 & 28 pts. The Dawgs are 13-2 SU/7-7-1 ATS in SEC road openers. Vandy has lost 7 straight SEC openers (2-5 ATS). The Dawgs get 12 returning starters back (#36 exp). Vandy also gets 12 starters back but overall is much less experienced (#107). The 'Dores do have 3 legit NFL caliber skill position players in RB Vaughn, WR Lipscomb and TE Pinckney. They are also breaking in a new QB in Ball St transfer Riley Neal (32 car sts) and must replace 3 Oline starters. In 4 meetings vs P5 foes at Ball St, Neal completed just 51% (3-4 ratio). This will obviously be the toughest competition that Neal has ever faced in a Georgia defense that returns 6 starters and only allowed 19.2 ppg last year. Vandy is 0-5 as a HD. The Dawgs are 13-6 ATS vs SEC foes.

**Virginia by 4 over PITTSBURGH** - Pitt has won the last 4 meetings incl 3 straight covers. UVA was ranked for the first time since 2011 last year but Pitt got 229 rush yds from RB Hall and won on a Friday night 23-13 (+7), giving the Panthers control of the ACC Coastal. The 'Hoos have 14 returning starters incl dual threat QB Perkins (65%, 25-9, 923 rush, 4.4). Pitt only has 11 starters back and they add former UMass HC Whipple to bring their pass attack to the 21st century after Kenny Pickett topped 200 yds just once all of last year. This is an early key ACC Coastal meeting and UVA has the experience edge (#56 to #79) better QB play, and is out for revenge, so we will take the Cavs by just over a field goal.

**TEXAS by 21 over Louisiana Tech** - First meeting. UT had won 17 straight home openers before losing in '17, but rebounded to beat Tulsa LY 28-21 (-22'). LT has won B2B road openers, but each were over G5 programs. These schools are on opposite ends of the spectrum in terms of experience returning. UT has just 8 starters back including only 3 on D, but does return pre-ssn 4th Tm AA QB Sam Ehlinger. While LT returns just 11 starters, they include QB J'Mar Smith, pre-ssn 1st Tm CUSA WR Adrian Hardy and their top 2 tacklers, not to mention a pair of pre-ssn CUSA 1st Tm members in DE Willie Baker and CB Amik Robertson. Bulldog HC Skip Holtz is 1-12 vs P5 foes, losing by an avg of 21 ppg and that sounds like the right line to use for this game.

**WASHINGTON ST by 26 over New Mexico St** - First meeting. WSt lost 3 straight home openers from 2014-'16, but has now won B2B by the same 31-0 score. NMSt is playing a P5 foe in their road opener for the 3rd straight season. After nearly upsetting AZSt in '17 as a 22' pt dog, they lost 48-10 (+21) at MN last year. The Aggies have the experience edge to begin the '19 campaign. They return 14 starters including QB Josh Adkins, their top 2 RB's, 3 OL, as well as leading tackler LB Javahn Ferguson. The Cougars have 13 starters back and must replace their P12 OPOY QB, leading RB, and leading tackler. While WSt will win big, we still expect an improved NMSt to keep it closer than expected.

**USC by 18 over Fresno St** - This is the first meeting between these in-state rivals since 2014 and FSt HC Jeff Tedford coached against USC all 11Y he was at Cal. The Bulldogs are one of the least experienced teams in the nation entering 2019. They have just 9 starters back including only 3 on OFF and must replace a 2nd Tm MW QB, a #6DC WR, 4 starting OL, and 4 of their top 5 tacklers. The Trojans enter the season off their first losing year since 2000! They have 11 starters back led by QB JT Daniels, their top 3 WR's, and a pair of pre-ssn 1st Tm P12 members in DL Jay Tufele and PR Tyler Vaughns. The Bulldogs allowed just 14.1 ppg (#3 FBS) LY and haven't allowed more than 30 points in 25 straight games! The ppg will go up and USC should be able to snap that 30 pt streak. FSt is 8-13 ATS vs non-conf foes and we'll call for the Trojans to win by over 2 td's.

**SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 1ST**

**OKLAHOMA vs Houston** - The host has won each of the regular season meetings as UH pulled the outright upset 33-23 (+12) in '16. UH has won 5 of their L/6 road openers including over P5 members AZ and LVille. Each is on opposite ends in terms of returning experience. OU has just 12 starters back and must replace their Heisman winning QB (#1DC) as well as a #1DC WR and 4 OL. While UH has a new HC in Dana Holgorsen and just 12 returning starters, among those returning are pre-ssn 1st Tm AAC QB D'Eriq King, 1st Tm AAC WR Marquez Stevenson, and 3 OL. HC Holgorsen has gone up against OU each of the L7Y while the HC at WV.

**MONDAY SEPTEMBER 2ND**

**LOUISVILLE vs Notre Dame** - This game probably packed more punch before Louisville fell apart last year which led to Bobby Petrino's firing. The only previous meeting was in '14 when ND missed a gm tying 32 yd fg on the final play. HC Satterfield comes over after leading App St to 4 straight seasons of 9+ wins. UL returns 16 starters from a 2 win team that was outscored by 24.3 ppg & out-gained by 131 ypg. The Cardinals have 10 starters back on a historically bad defense that allowed 44.2 ppg last year. The Irish return 13 starters after LY's undefeated reg season. Louisville does have an experience edge (#14 vs #98) but Notre Dame has huge edges on offense and defense plus they still have QB Book.

Oregon is the most experienced team in the country with 17 returning starters back. The bulk of that experience is on the Oline where the Ducks return all 5 starters and 153 career starts return. Auburn counters with our #2 rated Dline with 3 starters back including DT Derrick Brown (10.5 tfl LY). The Tigers also bring back all 5 Oline starters (104 car sts ret). Oregon should have an improved defense with 7 starters back incl 3 on their Dline The Ducks have a big edge at QB with Justin Herbert who turned down the NFL. This is Oregon's first neutral site opener since 2011. Auburn was fortunate to survive last year's neutral site opener vs Washington. 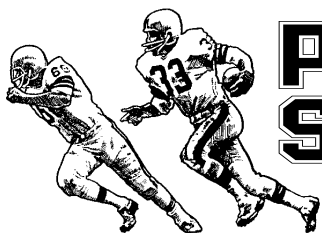
