NOW HITTING 88% OVER 11 YEARS!

The Post Draft Issue grades a team's offseason a little differently than most. The grades we put into Power Sweep predict whether a team's record will improve or decline for the upcoming season. We take EVERYTHING into account. Included in the analysis are coaching changes, the NFL Draft, Free Agent signings, Free Agent losses and even favorable or unfavorable schedules. The "A" & "D" grades have been extremely accurate over the years. We spend a great deal of time and effort making these grades and while there was no list in '11 (work stoppage), here is a recap of the past 26 years as well as the record from the last 11 years with grades ('09, '10 & '12-'20).

In 2020 we released a total of 7 teams which earned either an "A" or "D" grade. 6 of the 7 teams were correct with the Packers ("D" team, worse record) having the same 13-3 mark for the 2nd consecutive season.

These "A" and "D" are a huge help in determining which teams to bet on using the Vegas Over/Under season total. THIS YEAR THERE ARE 7 MORE TEAMS WITH THOSE VERY SPECIAL "A" and "D" GRADES.

Overview: The Chiefs continue to be one of the strongest teams in the NFL with a combined 38-10 record and 2 Super Bowl appearances over the last 3 seasons. This year the biggest changes come on their OL as the bookend duo of Eric Fisher and Mitchell Schwartz move on with Kyle Long, Joe Thuney and Orlando Brown added. Also added to the group are a pair of new C's in FA Austin Blythe and 2nd Rnd DC Creed Humphrey. The defense finished in the upper half of the rankings LY and remains virtually the same for 2021. Following their late November bye, the schedule gets much easier for the Chiefs as they take on just 1 team that finished 2020 with a winning record over the final 6. KC is clearly the favorite to grab another AFC West Title and yet another Super Bowl berth for the upcoming season.

Overview: While the Chargers have been able to finish in the Top 10 of both total offense and total defense the past 2 years, they have just a combined 12-20 mark in that span. The addition of 1st Rnd DC QB Justin Herbert had the offense clicking in the 2H of last season. This year he's joined by some solid talent in both FA and the draft including 1st Rnd DC OT Rashawn Slater. The defense also brings in some solid talent including FA LB Kyler Fackrell and 2nd Rnd DC CB Asante Samuel Jr. Similar to the Raiders, the biggest challenge will be getting past the Chiefs in the AFC West to land a DIV title. The schedule features a relatively rough slate early on including trips to WAS, KC and BAL. While improved, the overall 2021 record could be virtually the same.

The biggest changes come on the OL as FA C Nick Martin and 1st Rnd DC OT Alex Leatherwood are added to the mix with C Rodney Hudson, OG Gabe Jackson and OT Trent Brown moving on. The schedule looks challenging for the Silver & Black including a rough slate in the final month and a half. While there's clearly some talent in the roster, a Wild Card spot is likely the best that they can aim for with the front-running Chiefs also in the AFC West.

Overview: Injuries on both sides took a major toll on the Broncos a year ago with them sliding all the way down to #28 in scoring offense and #25 in scoring defense. Most of LY's key injured players (WR Courtland Sutton, LB Von Miller) return while QB Drew Lock will see some competition at the position with FA Teddy Bridgewater joining the unit. 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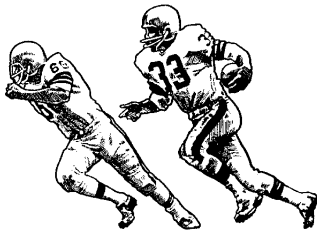
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
