

There are 3 main methods of handicapping, Fundamental, Situation & Technical. Fundamental handicapping or the analysis of personnel matchups & power ratings is our main method of handicapping. This accounts for roughly 50% of how we view a game. Situation handicapping (analysis of leardown, look ahead, systems, etc...) takes up approximately 25% of our handicapping. Technical handicapping (analysis of angles) takes up the rest. You should never base your final selection on 1 factor. To be a complete handicapper you must look at all 3 methods. Each week in Power Sweep we provide a system to add to your handicapping arsenal. This is done at the request of our subscribers who want handicapping tips & methods. Many times we will agree with the side that the system chooses. Sometimes the Fundamental & Technical aspects of a game will outweigh the system & we have the other side written up in Power Sweep. **We want to make it clear that the side we write up in Power Sweep is the side we are on.** If that is ever the case during a week, keep the system for future use, but be aware that the side we write-up in the Power Sweep Selections page is the side we are on.

Usc (+15) 38 OREGON 35 - We used USC as a Big Dog POW and thought USC had an excellent shot at pulling the upset of Oregon and they did. In fact, at one point USC led 38-14. Each team punted and USC fmbld the snap at their own 20 but UO fumbled it back on the next play 12:06. 2 punts. USC, who had WR speed that Stanford did not possess, with Lee and Woods - got a 59 yd TD pass to Lee, 7-0 (6:35). UO42 got 1 FD and on 4&8 was SOD. USC went 66/9pl for a TD, 14-0 (14:54). 2 punts. UO12 went 88/7pl and got a 29 yd TD pass to Thomas, 14-7 (5:53). USC50 went 50/7pl for a 4 yd TD pass, 21-7 (2:27). The Ducks34 went 57/12pl but LaMichael James fmbld at the 9 with :23 left. At half UO had a 220-215 yd edge. UO went 3&out to open the 3Q and USC blk'd a punt and rec'd at the 12 (13:33). They settled for a 26 yd FG, 24-7 (12:45). UO25 went 75/9pl for a TD, 38-27 (12:44). USC34 got 2 FD's but a pass was high off the rec hands and int'd and ret'd 9 yds to the UO40 (8:32) on 2&14. UO40 went 60/7pl for a TD and 2 pt to pull within 38-35 (7:05). USC28 got 3 FD's on a 58/8pl drive and had a 2&5 at the 10 but fmbld (2:31) and the Ducks had a chance. They stayed in the hurry up offense, not calling time-out and raced from their 14, 66/15. They had a FD at the 18 but on 4&12 settled for a 37 yd FG and missed it.

Fresno St 24 HAWAII 21 - UH was playing w/o QB Moniz and bkp's Graves and Austin comb to hit 19-40-244. FSU got a 16 yd run by Carr on the 1st play and a 44 yd TD pass to Saunders on the 2nd, 7-0 (11:21). FSU went 82/12pl for a 32 yd FG, 10-0 (5:38). UH40 went 29/9pl and fired incomplete on 4&5. FSU went 69/12pl for a 1 yd TD run, 17-0 (12:26). FSU28 went 39/8pl but missed a 50 yd FG (4:33). UH on Graves' 2nd poss (33) went 67/9pl for a TD, 17-7 with 1:00 left 1H. At half FSU had a 272-110 yd edge. UH opened the 3Q with a 78/9pl drive for a 24 yd TD pass, 17-14 (11:54). UH15 got 1 FD and a 69 yd TD pass stunningly put them in the lead, 21-17 (6:28). 2 punts. NEW MEXICO (+7') 21 Unlv 14 - UNLV has been traditionally one of the poorest road teams in the country but amazingly Las Vegas had them favored by a D on the road vs New Mexico. NM got an 80 yd TD pass on the first play to Long 7-0 (14:51). LV20 went 80/10pl and got a 45 yd TD by Bradford, 7-7 (8:50). NM20 went 80/14pl. On 4&5 pass interference gave them a FD to the LV30 and 6pl later they got a 1 yd TD run by Rodgers, 14-7 (:32). LV6 got 2 FD's and punted and NM42 went 38/7pl but missed a 37 yd FG. NM went 59/14pl but on 4&gl from the 1 was SOD with 1:39 left in the half so NM only led 14-7 but had a 249-155 yd edge. NM fmbld at the LV39 after a 16 yd run for a FD (12:02 3Q). 4 punts. LV went 72/9pl and got a 4 yd TD run by Cornett, 14-14 (14:22). NM28 went 43/9pl but had a 46 yd FG blk'd. 2 punts. LV15 got 1 FD and on 2&5 Barnhill gained 7 yds but fmbld. NM got a 27 yd pass to Solomon to the 7 and 2pl later a 2 yd TD run made it 21-14 with 1:15 left. UNLV12 was SOD on their own 19 on 4&3 (:32).

UL went 56/5pl for a TD, 14-7 to get back in it. ULM punted 21 yds and UL went 69/5pl for a TD, 14-14 (7:38). ULM punted 30 yds and UL got a 43/1pl TD pass to Green, 21-14 (5:15). ULM punted 33 yds and UL went 55/11pl for a 41 yd FG on a drive that incl 3 & 12, 3 & 9 and 3 & 10 conversions. The FG came with :03 left in the half. UL had a 272-188 yd edge at the half and led 24-14 (:03). ULM opened the 3Q with a 69/7pl drive for a TD. 3 punts. ULM went 71/12pl and got a 12 yd TD pass on 3 & gl, 28-24 (14:54). 4 punts. UL was int'd and ret'd 18 yds to their 12 and ULM got a TD 3pl later to appear to put it away, 35-24 (3:08). UL went 48/6pl and got a 16 yd TD pass (2pt ng) 35-30 (2:04). The onside kick was rec'd by UL and they went 39/3pl for a 3 yd TD run with :56 left. The 2 pt failed again and ULM27 got 1 FD on 4&10 got to the UL31 but ran out of time.
