NEWS AND NOTES

It was the largest comeback ever in the 105 meetings of the Apple Cup and allowed Washington St to avoid a winless Pac-12 season. If you look at the stats, it's surprising that WSU had to rally and force OT as they had 25-17 FD and 369-269 yd edges for the gm. WSU was not only playing without WR Marquess Wilson, of course, but also DE Travis Long who missed the first game of his entire college career. WSU was SOD on 4&2 at the UW43 on its first series then drove 75/14pl but settled for a 21 yd FG after a 1&g1 at the 6, 3-0. They were int'd at their own 20 and UW got a td 3pl later. WSU went 81/10pl for a td, 10-7 at the half with a 183-96 yd edge. UW took its first 3Q pass 89/13pl for a td then rec'd a fmb1 and went 16/4pl, its 2nd td drive of 20 yds or less. WSU was int'd at the UW31 but UW went 3&out. Then WSU fmb1'd at its own 28 and UW ret'd it to the 7. They had a td 3pl later, 28-10, their 3rd drive of less than 20 yds. WSU went 75/10pl and 47/4pl for td's then 42/9pl but on 3&1 fired in and settled for a 45 yd FG to tie it with 1:59 left. UW went 58/8pl on one of their best drives but missed a 35 yd FG. On the first play of OT, UW's Price was being chased and had to throw it away but

DT Pole caught it and ret'd it all the way down to the 5 but couldn't get in the EZ so WSU started on the 25. They got a FD to the 9 and nailed a 27 yd FG for the win...Louisville potentially had a big game vs Rutgers for the BE Title on deck and fortunately for them, RU lost which kept those dreams alive. This was a contest Connecticut led almost the entire game but UL scored with :21 left in regulation to force OT. UC QB Whitmer was inj'd after hitting 7-21-72 and McEntee, in relief, hit just 2-7-20. UL finished with a 401-241 yd edge. Both teams were off a bye and UC did have a 160-88 yd edge at the half. The first 4 poss were punts before UC went 51/8pl for 39 yd FG. After 3 punts UC went 66/10pl for a td, 10-0. UL went on a 43/14pl drive to the UC22 but after B2B sks punted on 4&25. The 3Q opened with 5 punts. UC was int'd at its 35 but UL missed a 46 yd FG after gaining 6 yds. UL went 75/11pl and got a 19 yd FG after a 1&g1 at the 2, 10-3 (11:40). UL was SOD on 4&10 at UC46 (6:29) and UC got 1 FD and punted with 3:01 left. UL went 92/13pl and got a 6 yd td pass to force OT. Each team got a 37 yd FG in the 1st OT and a td in the 2OT then Bridgewater was int'd in the

3OT on 3&g1 from the 6 and UC got a 30 yd FG... TCU was playing on Thanksgiving for the first time since 1928 and upset T-day veteran Texas on the road. The key to the game was turnovers as UT had a 4-1 TO deficit. UT finished the game with 22-15 FD and 300-299 yd edges but TCU did have a 217-86 rush edge. On UT's opening drive, Ash was int'd at the TCU6. On their 3rd drive, from the TCU18, Ash was int'd at the 2. Down 7-3, UT gave TCU a cheap td before the half when Ash was sk'd and fmb1'd back at his own 16 with 2:45 left. TCU went 16/3pl for a td and led 14-3 despite only having a 176-150 yd edge. UT got a short FG on its 1st poss of the 3Q, but TCU got 18 and 41 yd FG's to lead 20-6. McCoy came in with 9:47 left but UT was SOD at the TCU36 on 4&3. UT took over with 5:58 left and went 82/9pl for an 8 yd td run by Hills with 3:07 left. UT forced a 3&out and took over with 1:44 left. McCoy got a 13 yd run to the 47 but on 1&10 scrambled around and while he could have easily thrown the ball away instead he threw it into a crowd and was int'd at the TCU40 and the Longhorns saw their BCS bowl hopes fall by the wayside.

3★ HAWAII over South Alabama - First meeting. UH is 6-12 in reg ssn home finales but those have been mostly vs BCS teams. In the L9Y they were favored against a non-BCS twice in their home finale and covered both winning SU by 38 and 11. This will be an 8,644 mile round trip, USA's longest prior road trip was to Kent St LY (1,934) and this is their 3rd road game in 4 wks. UH ended its 8 gm losing streak, covering its 2nd straight with their 48-10 (+3) win over UNLV. The Warriors led 31-0 at the half and 41-0 after 3Q's finishing with 18-11 FD and 340-203 yd edges and also had a 69 yd PR td and a 38 yd IR td. QB Schroeder (159, 51%, 10-10) has struggled all ssn with the transition to a pro style off which lacks balance (#113 FBS rush, 98, 2.7). The D has been bullied up front allowing 206 rush ypg (4.6) thanks to several inj's. USA lost its 5th straight to fall to 2-10 in their inaugural FBS season after losing to Louisiana 52-30 (+18) LW. UL led just 17-16 late 1H when they hit a 28 yd td pass with :15 left to take an 8 pt lead into the locker room. UL scored td's on their 1st 2 2H drives to put the gm away. QB Metheny (170, 56%, 12-10) did pass for a ssn high 360 vs the Cajuns. The Jags have had issues with TO's as their -13 margin attests. After a rough transition yr, the Warriors will want to end the season on a strong note in front of the hometown fans while we think USA will have a hard time with all of the distractions.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ UNDER Texas/KANSAS ST - Since '99 the dog is a perfect 7-0 ATS with 6 outright upsets (5 by KSU). LY UT (-8) was out to avenge a 39-14 spanking on the road at KSU the previous yr. In that game, UT had finished with a 412-290 yd edge but trailed 24-0 at the half and got a garbage td with :31 left. LY KSU QB Klein was sk'd 5 times and hit just 9-17 passes. Just before the half KSU would get a td to lead 10-3. After an int KSU drove 37 yds for a td. UT settled for a 26 yd FG and ended up losing 17-13 despite the large stat edges (310-121 yd, 15-9 FD). Even though they won, KSU HC Snyder said after the game about the UT D, "they just beat the tar out of us." Texas is just 2-6 SU in the series with their largest wins by 4 and 3 pts and their avg loss by 18.5 ppg!!! The Horns (-7) lost to TCU 20-13 on Thanksgiving as UT finished with a 22-15 FD edge but TO's doomed them as QB Ash had 3 incl td's at the TCU1 and 6 and a fmb'l which set up a 16 yd Frog td drive. McCoy (11-17-119-0-1) played in both halves and led a 4Q td drive after Ash (ribs) left the gm for good. All 7 of Ash's int's TY have come in the opp's RZ (223, 68%, 17-7). KSU had the bye to get over their bubble bursting loss to Baylor which likely cost them a chance at the national title. The Cats can clinch their 1st B12 title s/'03 with a win here and keep QB Klein (210, 67%, 14-6, 787 rush, 20 td) in the Heisman hunt. The Cats have been outgained by their L/4 opp by 68 ypg but the FBS's best TO margin (+21) kept the win streak alive until Baylor where they had a negative TO margin (-1) for just the 2nd time TY. Snyder is off of a SU loss (23-13 ATS) with extra time to game plan during the bye, but the dog rules this series. With that in mind, we'll look at a Kansas St offense that has averaged just 310 ypg its L/2 gms (including Baylor's D!), while Texas continues to have its QB issues on offense. Horns games have gone Under 4 straight weeks (avg 41 combined ppg) and LW we cashed a Thursday Marquee on the Texas/TCU Under and it covered by 25 points. We'll go right back to it here. **FORECAST: UNDER Texas/KANSAS ST**

Thursday, November 29th

Louisville at RUTGERS - The "BE Champ Gm" and a trip to the Orange Bowl is on the line here. The home team is 5-2 SU/ATS in this series. LY UL (-1) won 16-14 as RU QB Nova had 2 int's on his first 4 passes and 3 int's for the gm (UL +2 TO's). RU missed 2 chipshot FG's in the 1H. They needed a td on 4&1 on the final play of the half to tie it at 7 despite a 190-108 yd edge. Trailing 16-14 RU was int'd at its own 40 with 1:41 left. UL is 1-4 in New Brunswick but won LTH. They scored td's on their first 4 drives to lead 28-0 and won 40-13 (-3). Both of these tms come in off conf losses. UL trailed Conn for much of the gm (10-0 after 3Q's) before rallying to force OT. In the 3rd OT, Conn int'd a beat-up Bridgewater (broken wrist, inj'd leg) in the EZ and pulled out the 23-20 upset (+10') giving us another outright upset winner for the Big Dog POW (Thursdays on your Northcoast Debit Card for \$9). After starting the ssn 9-0, the Cards have now lost B2B. The Knights haven't fared much better after their 7-0 start as they have dropped 2 of their L/4 incl LW's 27-6 (+1) drubbing at the hands of Pitt getting outgained 365-207. While HC Flood denied that the B10 news prior to the gm had no effect on his tm, they certainly didn't play like it as the gm really had no meaning on the BE Champ. These tms look to be evenly matched talent-wise as while UL has the off edge (#52-90), RU has the def edge (#14-51). MAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • Ford Field • Detroit MI

Northern Illinois 38 Kent St 34 - This will mark the first time the MAC Champ has featured 2 Top 25 teams and is also the first matchup of MAC Top 25 tms s/'03. This is the Huskies 3rd str appearance in the MAC Champ gm and they will be going for B2B championships here after rallying from a 20-0 deficit LY to beat Ohio 23-20 (-3). This is Kent's 1st appearance. NI has won the L/5 meetings SU/ATS by an avg of 31-11 and LY the Huskies (-16') beat Kent at home 40-10 and held them to just 64 total yds. Kent's only td came off a 36 yd FR td as the Golden Flashes did not complete a pass in the 1H. TY both tms come in on hot streaks as NI has won 11 consec gms (8-3 ATS) since their opening gm loss to Iowa by a pt while Kent has won 10 str after a loss to KY and have covered 9 of those 10 gms. LW both tms already had their div titles wrapped up and did not have much to play for other than pride and poll position but both came away with impressive wins. NI (-21) hammered EM 49-7 on a snow-covered field as they had 24-15 FD and 415-227 yd edges. RB Daniels had a career-high 4 td's and QB Lynch, one week after becoming the 1st ply'r in NCAA history with a 400+ pass/150+ rush gm, had 275 total yds. Kent continued its best ssn in schl hist (90Y) with a 28-6 (-9') win over Ohio. Kent jumped out to a 21-0 1Q lead and despite being outFD'd 22-15, the gm was never in doubt as the Kent D finished w/8 sks. Kent has used the same formula all ssn on off as they use the 6'0" 250 lb RB Durham (1176, 5.0, 14 td) early to wear down opposing D's then insert the speedy Archer (1337, 9.7, 14 td) as a change of pace to catch the D off guard. Their QB Keith is nothing more than a gm manager as he is just #87 in the NCAA in pass eff (11-7 ratio). While their D (#74) has been nothing spectacular giving up 410 ypg, they have forced 35 TO's (#2 in the NCAA). While we appreciate the job HC Hazell has done TY and the ball has seemed to bounce their way, the fact is that NI has all of the talent edges (off #29-51, def #49-75), ST's #38-76) and clearly has the better QB as Lynch leads the NCAA in rush yds among QB's (1611, 6.9, 16 td). Also against their 6 common opp's each went 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS but NI was +95 ypg while Kent was +6 ypg. The Huskies make it B2B MAC Titles!

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • Stanford Stadium • Stanford, CA

STANFORD 27 UCLA 21 - It's Déjà vu all over again here as these two meet for the 2nd consec week. UCLA had a run of 5 wins SU in this series from '04-'08 but Stan is now 4-0 SU/ATS winning by an avg of 35-13 (+87 ypg). LW while the Bruins had the P12 South Div already wrapped up, Stan needed a win

to get here and played like it (also, we think deep down UCLA would have preferred a trip here instead of a trip to Autzen which would have happened had the Bruins won). The Cardinal (-3) led 21-10 at HT and blew the gm open in the 3Q. After a UCLA int, they drove 42/4pl for a td, then the Bruins fmb'l'd the ensuing KO and Stan ret'd it 11 yds for a td, 35-10 (7:28). The yds were relatively close at 381-334. LY here Stan (-22') got the frontdoor cover on a 59/12pl drive for a td with 1:51 left after UCLA had been SOD on 4&10. The HT is 8-3-1 ATS in the series. The diff between Stan's play recently can be attributed to rFR QB Hogan who is comp 73% of his passes with an 8-3 ratio and gives D's an added dimension to defend as he can run. Coming into the yr, many questioned whether the Cardinal could do it without QB Luck but there's no question now that Stan's physical play on both sides of the LOS in a spread heavy up-tempo P12 has allowed them to achieve 3 str 10 win ssn for the 1st time in schl hist. UCLA HC Mora, Jr has done a masterful job in his 1st yr awakening what we felt was a "Sleeping Giant" in CFB helping the Bruins achieve 9 wins for the 1st time s/'05. He's done it with a rFR QB in Hundley who is avg 270 ypg (68%) with a 26-10 ratio while RB Franklin has 1,506 (6.1) and an attacking D that has 40 sks (Stan #1 in NCAA w/53 sks). While most will be tempted to play on the Cardinal here in a road/home dichotomy expecting the same results as LW, keep in mind at home TY despite its 6-0 SU record, Stan is only outgaining its foes by 15 ypg (2-4 ATS). In his post gm presser, Stan HC Shaw said, "I expect them to give us everything. It's going to be 10 times harder than this game was. We're going to get their best shot." We agree as this one will be decided by a td or less.

Saturday, December 1st

Pittsburgh 30 USF 20 - Pitt is 4-0 SU (3-1 ATS) in this series with their avg win by a score of 32-16 (+127 ypg) despite the avg line being +2! LY we used Pitt as a Thursday Night Marquee Play and the 2-2 Panthers were a 3 pt dog to #16 USF (4-0). RB Graham had a huge night rushing for 226 yds and Pitt rolled up a 523-425 yd edge in their 44-17 win, covering by 30 pts! These tms look to be going in opposite directions as BE cellar dweller USF will most likely be playing for a new HC next year as they sit at 3-8 SU/ATS after LW's 27-10 loss (+14) to Cincy. Third string QB Floyd should again get the start here and is avg 176 ypg (55%) with an 0-2 ratio in the L/2 gms. The Panthers have come a long way from their 0-2 start going 5-4 in their L/9 gms (5 wins by an avg of 26 ppg, 4 losses by an avg of 5 ppg). LW off a bye against a Rutgers tm that didn't have much to play for, the Panthers (-1) jumped out to a 21-0 HT lead and cruised in the 2H of a 27-6 win over prev BE unbeaten Rutgers. Pitt outgained RU 365-207 and QB Sunseri (kudos to HC Chryst) continued his surprising ssn w/227 yds and a 2-0 ratio that gives him a shocking 18-2 ratio on the yr. Sr RB Graham also added 113 yds and is now just 52 yds away from topping the 1,000 yd mark a yr after an ACL inj. It should be noted that Holtz has gone an abysmal 0-9-1 ATS in BE gms during his tenure here and USF is 3-6 SU in home finales with 3 str losses by 9 ppg. Pitt has all the edges (off #47-77, def #43-67, ST's #25-81) and in one of the weirder stat lines we've seen all yr, the Panthers TY have won 2 SU, lost 2, won 2, lost 2 and now we'll predict they finish w/2 str wins while clinching their 5th straight bowl berth.

Oklahoma 31 TCU 24 - There have been just 2 recent meetings and the Frogs lost 10-9 (+5) here in '98 and pulled the huge upset of #7 OU on the road in '05 opener winning 17-10 as a 25 pt dog. OU is off of the first OT game in Bedlam history, a 51-48 comeback win over their rivals and is just 5-10 ATS as an AF. Despite 44-23 FD and 618-490 yd edges the Sooners never led OSU in regulation tying the gm on a 1 yd 4th down td run with :04 left. After holding the Cowboys to a FG in OT, the Sooners' Clay broke 2 tkls on the GW 18 yd td run. B12's all-time passing leader Jones (345 ypg, 66%, 27-9) has thrown for more than 500 yds while leading 4Q comebacks in B2B gms becoming the 1st FBS QB to throw for 3,000 yds and 26 td's in 4 different yrs. The Sooners are #9 pass eff D (195, 51%, 8-12) but their base 4-2-5 D has struggled vs the run allowing 200+ yds 6 times TY and in the L/3 gms they've allowed 304 rush ypg (6.6). TCU was a perfect 4-0 in the rare role of HD over the previous 11Y but are 0-2 in the role in their 1st B12 season TY. On Thanksgiving the Frogs took advantage of 4 Horns TO's in beating Texas 20-13. On UT's 1st 4 pass QB Ash was int'd at the TCU6 and 1, the Horns settled for a 25 yd FG after driving to the Frogs8 and then Ash fmb'l'd at the UT16 which set the Frogs up for a td. Even though Texas finished with a 22-15 FD edge, TCU finished with a 217-86 rush yd edge. Oddly, the Frogs and QB Boykin (162 ypg, 59%, 14-9, 344 rush) are 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS on the road in B12 play but are 0-3 SU/ATS at home in their newly refurbished stadium. Frosh DE Fields leads the B12 in sks (9) and tfl (17.5) as the Frogs lead the conf in tfl D (324). The Sooners still have a shot at the B12 Title and automatic BCS bid if they win here while KSU loses. Scoreboard watching won't be a factor however as this game is being played at 11 am CT while the KSU/Texas game kicks off at 7 pm CT.

Oklahoma St 45 BAYLOR 35 - OSU is 6-0 SU/ATS vs Baylor and despite being favored by an avg of 13 ppg, they have won their games by 30 ppg (avg cover 17 pts). LY at home they won 59-24. It was a bit of a strange game as OSU led 35-0 at the half but BU had 5 blown opportunities being SOD at the 1, missing a 48 yd FG, int'd in the EZ from the 5, SOD at the 32 and int'd at the OSU26. BU finished with a 622-601 yd edge but trailed 49-3 into the 4Q with BU gaining 234 yds in the 4Q. The HT is 8-2 ATS but OSU won its last 2 here. OSU will be salty after blowing a DD 2H lead to their rival in a 51-48 OT loss to Oklahoma, the 1st OT gm in Bedlam history. OU finished with 618-490 yd and 44-23 FD edges but missed a 32 yd FG, had a long IR set up a 9 yd td drive, settled for FG's of 25 and 30, fmb'l'd at the OSU14 and were SOD at the OSU33. OU drove 90/17pl for a td on 4&gl with :04 left to tie it. After OSU kicked a FG in OT, the Sooners got the GW 18 yd td run for their 1st lead in the game. For the 2nd straight gm OSU used QB's Chelf (19-37-253-1-1, 63 rush) with the more mobile Walsh to run the short yard/goal line off. BU became bowl elig for a 3rd straight ssn for the 1st time in school history after knocking off Texas Tech 52-45 in OT. The Bears were SOD at the TT2 in the 1H and missed 3 FG's incl a 48 yd'r on the final play of regulation but still were able to rally from a 14 pt deficit. TT helped the cause with 4 TO's incl a 55 yd IR td which gave BU its first lead of the gm. The Bears finished with a 674-567 yd edge and after scoring a td on their OT poss held TT to a 4&out. QB Florence (348, 61%, 30-13) pilots the nation's #1 off and RB Seastrunk's emergence (618 tfl yds and 6 td's) has given the Bears big play threats on both the ground and in the air with the nation's leading rec Williams (1693, 19.0). Bears have a TO margin of +13 in their wins and -9 in their losses. Both tms come in hot w/BU having 4 str covers and OSU covering 5 of 6 but OSU is 13-7 ATS off a SU loss as this gm will be for a better bowl destination.

Boise St 31 NEVADA 24 - The last time BSU traveled to Reno, 2 missed FG's cost them an undefeated season and a BCS bowl berth as they lost 34-31 in OT. LY they were out for revenge but QB Moore was wearing a knee brace and hit a career low 19-33-142 and BSU (-27') "only" won, 30-10. BSU led 20-0 at the half with a 187-50 yd edge. The home team has won 3 in a row SU but Boise is 11-1 SU in the series and prior to their upset loss in 2010 had won 4 in a row here in Nevada by 26 ppg SU and covered all 4. BSU can clinch a 3 way share of their first (and possibly last) MW crown with a win here. This isn't your father's Broncos squad however as they're doing it almost exclusively on D as they've held their last 9 opp to 7 1H pts and for the yr they have our #26 D allowing just 293 ypg and 14.4 ppg. QB Southwick (206, 66%, 15-7) is supported by dependable RB Harper (935, 5.0, 20, 14 td). In their previous 4 contests vs bowl elig tms TY BSU is avg just 14.8 ppg and 270 ypg. This is the 7-4 Wolfpack's last shot at the team they see as their top out of state rival in the foreseeable future. QB Fajardo (233, 66%, 17-7, 900 rush, 5.9) and the FBS's #2 rusher Jefferson (1564, 5.0, 20, 20 td) headline the only off in the FBS which has scored 30+ pts in every gm this ssn. The problem has been a D (our #103) which has all'd 33 ppg and 213 rush ypg (5.1). With both teams pretty much locked into their bowl destinations (BSU to Las Vegas, UN to New Mexico) the Broncos finish the conf series with another W.

WEST VIRGINIA 45 Kansas 24 - WV beat KU 21-0 in 1941 in Morgantown (only prior gm). Kansas is off a bye while WV is playing for a 5th straight week. WV is 0-5 ATS as a HF in home finales. The Mountaineers ended their painful 5 gm slide by beating ISU 31-24 on Black Friday. WV trailed 24-23 mid-4Q when a 75 yd catch and run by Austin and 2 pt conv gave them the 7 pt lead. ISU drove to the WV7 but RB Woody fmbld the ball into the EZ where it was rec'd by the Mountaineers who then ran out the clock. WV finished with a 475-396 yd edge. Since moving from WR to RB for L/2 gms the FBS's reception leader Austin (106, 10.8) has 599 ttl yds and 3 td's taking the pressure off of QB Smith (327, 70%, 37-5). Despite being in the FBS's bottom 10 in most D categories the rush D hasn't been bad allowing just 141 ypg (3.6). KU is the only B12 tm that will be staying home for the holidays and will look to end losing streaks of 10 gms overall, 20 in conf play and 21 on the road. The Hawks are 0-5 SU/2-3 ATS on the road TY vs 5 bowl tms losing their last road contest in 2OT to TT in Lubbock. KU is #2 B12 rushing led by thunder and lightning combo of Pierson (730, 6.6) and Sims (956, 4.8). The pass D allows 279 ypg (66%) with a 23-10 ratio. The Mountaineers extend KU's losing streaks another year.

TEXAS ST 33 New Mexico St 27 - First meeting. TSU HC Franchione won his L/5 vs NMSt as the HC at NM. TSU is 7-3 in reg ssn home finales but 0-2 the L2Y. The Aggies have dropped 16 str WAC road gms by 22 ppg (2-27 overall). Both get a shot to end long losing streaks here as the Bobcats have dropped 5 straight after LW's 38-31 loss at I-35 rival UTSA while NMSt has dropped 10 in a row after LW's 50-14 loss to BYU (+28). TSU (-1) never led the gm as the Roadrunners jumped out to a 31-14 early 3Q lead and they finished with a 499-392 yd edge. TSU scored a td with 1:40 left to pull within 1 score but UTSA rec'd the onside K and ran out the clock. TSU's offense is led by QB Rutherford (188, 66%, 14-5, 459 rush). The Bobcats are the only tm in the country to allow over 230 ypg both rushing (237, 5.8) and passing (253, 61%, 24-13). With HC Walker likely coaching his final home gm the Aggies led BYU 7-0 early 2Q before the slumbering Cougars woke up scoring on 9 of their final 10 poss finishing with 29-10 FD and 520-187 yd edges. NMSt hasn't scored more than 14 pts in a gm in 7 of their L/8 thanks to a weak run gm (91, 2.9) which allows D's to key on Manley (229, 54%, 16-10). The D lacks big play ability with just 9 sks while forcing just 9 TO's TY. TSU is 7-4 ATS this ssn and appears to still be playing hard for Franchione while NMSt is 3-7-1 ATS and Walker even questioned whether his own tm quit a few wks ago vs SJSU. With that said it is tough for us to back TSU here as a DD HF.

ARKANSAS ST 34 Middle Tennessee 30 - ASU had lost 7 str trips to Murfreesboro but LY was an 11 pt AF. ASU led 25-2 with 5:45 left in the half but MT scored 17 pts to pull with 25-19 and ASU only had a 236-231 yd edge. ASU scored two 3Q td's and another with 7:54 left for the 45-19 road win and did finish with a 536-299 yd edge. The HT is 4-1 SU and 3-2 ATS. LTH MT had 7 TO's (FBS era high). MT trailed just 23-17 at HT but opened the 2H w/5 str drives ending in TO's and ASU won 51-24 (-1). This is the SBC Super Bowl as both tms come in 6-1 in division play with 8-3 records overall after MT's 24-21 win over Troy (-3) LW set up this matchup. The Raiders trailed 21-16 mid-4Q with Troy driving when Byard got a 77 yd IR to plus the 2 pt conv to give MT a 24-21 lead. Troy drove to the MT35 on their final poss but was sold as the Raiders were able to run out the clock. Troy finished with 23-10 FD and 472-328 yd edges but had 5 TO's incl that costly pick 6X. The Raiders are led by QB Kilgore (223, 64%, 16-4) who keeps mistakes to a minimum as MT has a +12 TO margin. The D has been burned for 254 pass ypg (66%) with a 19-12 ratio. ASU is fresh off a bye after winning their 8th straight conf road gm 41-34 (-3) at Troy. The Red Wolves record setting off is led by the SBC's all-time pass leader Aplin who's thrown for 263 ypg (66%) with a 20-4 ratio TY. RB Oku (922, 4.5) keeps D's honest. ASU has the edges on both sides of the ball (#33-78 off, #80-91 D) but MT has been underrated at 7-3-1 ATS TY and keeps it close.

Louisiana 38 FLORIDA ATLANTIC 28 - LY we used FAU (+8) on the road as a Big Dog POW and they nearly got the outright upset winner. FAU led 17-7 in 2Q but trailed 21-20 at the half. FAU needed a 48,12, 12 yd td pass to tie it with 1:48 left but UL got a 26 yd FG on the final play for the 37-34 home win. FAU is 5-2 SU in the series and 6-1 ATS but the HT is just 2-5 ATS. The dog is 6-1 ATS with 3 outright upsets. The 7-4 Cajuns are assured of going bowling for a 2nd straight ssn but that didn't stop them from beating S Alabama 52-30 (-18) LW on Senior Day. UL led just 17-16 late 1H when QB Broadway hit a 28 yd td pass with :15 left 2Q which put them in the lead for good. UL had a 538-414 yd edge and ex-starting QB Gautier (2-4-32-1-0) played in the 2H for the 1st time since Sept 29 due to a broken hand. Broadway has done well in his absence leading the SBC in pass eff (214 ypg, 65%, 15-8). In their last outing prior to the bye FAU (-1) lost 34-24 to Shula Bowl rival FIU which ended their streak of 8 straight covers. After the Owls took their 1st lead of the gm mid-3Q, FIU ret'd the ensuing KO 100 yds for a td and didn't look back. QB Wilbert (221, 64%, 16-4) is the offense as the run gm avg's just 109 ypg (3.1). The D allows 195 rush ypg (4.7). The Cajuns have the talent edges (#38-110 off, #85-95 D, #54-123 ST) and are playing for bowl positioning here with 9 potential destinations in the mix.

CUSA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • H.A. Chapman Stadium • Tulsa, OK

Ucf 28 TULSA 27 - UCF is 2-4 SU/ATS vs Tulsa having met in 2 CUSA Title gms ('05 inaugural & '07 played twice). UCF has lost its only 2 trips here incl 2 wks ago where the Knights (+1) were outFD'd 26-14 and outgained 461-235 in a 23-21 loss. Despite coming in with much better numbers on the ssn QB Boriles was outplayed by TU QB Green as the Hurricane had constant pressure on him (4 sks). LW UCF was in a must-win situation to lock up the East and they beat UAB 49-24 (-22) thanks to All-Everything McDuffie who had 3 rushing td's. Meanwhile, Tulsa already having the CUSA Champ gm locked, up fell to SMU 35-27 (-5). The Golden Hurricane found themselves down 35-6 in the 3Q before a furious rally had them come just 1 yd short as the last play of the gm was a 34 yd pass down to the one. QB Green was sensational completing a career-high 36-64-413-3-1. While we normally like to find hidden value in prev wks box scores, a quick glance may have us leaning with Tulsa as they outgained SMU in the loss 591-305 while UCF was outgained 599-473 in a win. However, keep in mind that UCF was up big throughout the gm LW while Tulsa was down big which accounts for much of those yardage edges. Like we wrote coming into the last meeting 2W ago, both of these tms are eerily similar as they are both 9-3 SU and the off (Tulsa #41-50) and def (Tulsa #37-45) are close talent-wise. We expect the gm to come down to the wire again and it should be noted that UCF has the big ST's edge (#23-75).

SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • Georgia Dome • Atlanta, GA

Alabama 27 Georgia 20 - What in essence is a national title semifinal as the winner here will advance to play #1 Notre Dame in the national champ gm in Miami on Jan. 7. These two haven't played s/'08 when #8 Bama (+6) beat #3 Georgia on the road 41-30, a gm that many Bama fans point to as one of the key wins which got the Crimson Tide's recent run of dominance started. The Tide/Bulldogs have played just 6x in the L/20 yrs (3-3 split, UGA 4-2 ATS) and have not met here in the SEC Champ gm. In fact, this is the Tide's 8th appearance in the SEC Title gm (3-4 SU) but 1st against a tm other than UF. UGA makes its 2nd str trip here and its 5th appearance in the Richt era (2-2 SU/ATS). While not many can argue that these two don't deserve to be here as Bama beat LSU on the road 21-17 and UGA handed UF its only loss 17-9 (thanks to 6 UF TO's), it should be noted that both benefitted from rather fortunate SEC scheduling as UGA skipped out on the top 3 tms in the West (Bama, LSU and A&M) while Bama didn't play the top 3 tms in the East (UGA, UF and SC). Both come in off blowout wins of their rivals as Bama (-34) crushed Auburn 49-0 (most lopsided Iron Bowl in 64 yrs) rolling up 25-7 FD and 483-163 yd edges and led 42-0 at HT. Meanwhile, UGA rolled

to a 42-10 (-14) win over GT as they led 42-3 midway through the 3Q but were outgained 426-379 and outFD'd 26-18. They did avg an astonishing 10.5 yds per play in the 1H. Both tms are led by vet QB's as Murray and McCarron are #1-2 in the NCAA in pass eff and have comb for a 55-9 ratio! They also have stout D's as while Bama's ranks #1 in most categories, one could argue that UGA's is more talented and since S Williams called out the D prior to the UF gm, they've allowed just 9 ppg in the L/5 gms. The Bama D did give up 400+ yds in B2B gms vs LSU/A&M earlier TY while UGA OC Bobo has called this UGA off the best he's ever seen as they are avg a schl rec'd 38 ppg. While each has Top 20 units on both off/def, Bama does have the significant ST's edge (#22-71) and Saban is 7-2 SU in his L/9 gms vs Top 20 tms while Richt is 1-6 in his L/7.

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • Bank of America Stadium • Charlotte, NC

Florida St 41 Georgia Tech 24 - FSU is making its 2nd trip here in the L/3 yrs (lost 44-33, +3' to VT) and just its 3rd appearance in the ACC Champ gm ever while GT is also making its 3rd appearance (1-1 SU/ATS). These two have not played s/'09 and after losing 12 str to the Noles under Johnson GT has won 2 str incl 49-44 (+3) at FSU in that last meeting. This will be the 1st time though that Fisher sees the GT option as HC along w/DC Stoops. Both tms come in off of embarrassing losses to their SEC rivals as GT despite outgaining (426-379) and outFD'ing UGA (26-18) lost 42-10 (+14) as they gave up 10.5 yds per play in the 1H and fell behind 42-3 in the mid-3Q! FSU (-7) found themselves down 13-0 late 2Q before rallying to take a 20-13 lead over UF. However, they were doomed by 5 TO's and all'd the Gators to score 24 4Q pts in a devastating 37-26 loss that crushed what slim chances they had left of playing for the nat'l title. QB Manuel picked a bad time to have his worst gm of the ssn as he completed just 18-33-182-1-3 and also accounted for a key fmb'l late (shaken up on play but ret'd) that all'd UF to take the lead for good. The D which entered #1 in the country, was also disappointing as they all'd a ssn-high 244 rush yds which is not a good thing entering a wk when you're taking on the option. However, their issues pale in comparison to GT's as the Jackets who fired their DC at mid-season have all'd 40+ in 6 gms TY. FSU has the edges across the board (off #10-23, def #5-53, ST's #2-66) and vs the 6 common opp FSU is 6-0 SU/2-4 ATS (avg line -23) outscoring them by an avg of 42-18 (505-283 yd edge) while GT is 3-3 SU/4-2 ATS (avg line -5) outscoring its foes 33-27 (434-396 yd edge). While one might think that FSU may come in flat, the fact is that they have an opportunity to lock up their 1st trip to the BCS s/'05 and after a couple of series adjusting to the option, their speedy LB's will take over.

BIG TEN CHAMPIONSHIP GAME • Lucas Oil Stadium • Indianapolis, IN

NEBRASKA 27 Wisconsin 24 - Since NU joined the B10 LY these tms have met twice with the home tm 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS. The 2 met in the B10 opener on Sept 29th with the Huskers (-11) rallying from a 17 pt deficit to win 30-27 with 24-17 FD and 440-295 yd edges. NU trailed 27-10 in the 3Q but scored 20 pts on 4 straight poss while holding the Badgers in check. RB Ball lost his 1st career fmb'l at the UW49 which ended the Badgers final poss. Due to OSU and PSU's post ssn bans UW clinched the spot in this gm on Nov 10th with their huge 62-14 win over Indiana which we used as our 5★ College GOY. Since then the Badgers are 0-2 SU/ATS losing to both the Bucks and Lions. UW tied both of those gms in the final :20 of regulation on a td pass only to lose it in OT. QB Phillips (129 ypg, 53%, 4-1) has been steady with the job description basically to avoid TO's and hand the ball off to the FBS's new career td leader Ball (1593, 5.0). UW's top tk'r LB Bolland (hamstring) has missed the last 2 but is expected to return here to help a solid run D (111, 3.4) vs the B10's top offense. The Huskers clinched their spot in Indy with a 13-7 Black Friday win over Iowa. On a chilly day with wind gusts up to 40 mph NU trailed 7-3 at the break and didn't take the lead until late 3Q thanks to the return of RB Burkhead (69, 4.3) who teamed with Martinez to give the Hawks a 200-108 rush yd edge. B10 pass eff leader Martinez (207, 63%, 21-8, 833 rush) has led 5 2H comeback wins TY with his top target being big play threat Bell (789, 17.9). NU allows 166 rush ypg (4.2). Even though the Huskers clinched their spot in this gm 2 wks after the Badgers expect more NU fans to pack Indy as this has been considered a down season for Wisky after B2B B10 Titles while the Huskers have a chance to win their 1st league title s/'99.

4★ Houston over TENNESSEE - HOU has some much needed rest after B2B OT games in 5 days but its unknown if #1 CB Joseph (hamstring) will play. Phillips will be fuming after giving up over 500 yds despite the circumstances. Inc playoffs HOU is 5-0 SU/ATS after giving up 350+ yds allowing an avg of 249 yds/11 ppg not counting DET under Phillips. HOU has monster stat edges with the #3 and #6 units (+8 TO's) vs TEN's #24 and #29 units (-4 TO's) but the best edge is HOU's #5 scoring defense (19.2 ppg) vs #31 TEN's (30.5). Locker only has 3 pass att's vs HOU dislocating his shoulder in the 38-14 loss (+12.5) in the 1st meeting TY. While HOU is a run oriented team (143 ypg 4.2) getting the #27 rush def (130 ypg 4.3) a key matchup is Schaub who since the GB game is avg 292 ypg (66%) with a 11-5 ratio (2 int vs CHI) getting a TEN defense allowing a 275 ypg (70% NFL worst) with a 22-10 ratio. Despite the layoff and having a MNF game vs NE on deck the Texans won't overlook the Titans here.

FORECAST: Houston 31 TENNESSEE 17

3★ NY JETS over Arizona - NYJ has a clear situational edge at home for the 2nd straight vs Arizona playing in an early game in a div sandwich (AD's are 8-14 ATS). The Cardinals QB carousel landed on Ryan Lindley at Atlanta and 7 FD's with 178 yards was the result in a very misleading cover. LW he threw 51 passes (31 comp) but finished with a 0-4 ratio. The Jets are off a Thanksgiving loss and while most teams would prefer the extra rest at home they're dealing with the NY media and fan base off a 30 point loss to your rival which doesn't sound very restful. The one positive for the Jets is that they totaled a season high 405 yards with 12 FD's at HT and 25 overall but turned it over twice inside the NE 31 and were SOD on 4&gl from the 1. The Jets D has been a consistent and they always bounce back after allowing 400+ yards. This is the first time they allowed 400 TY and only the 6th time since '09 giving up 245 ypg and 13 FD's/gm the following week. Weather won't be a factor for the SDSt alum QB but the disposition of the opposing D will certainly be frosty.

OTHER SELECTION

2★ New England over MIAMI - MIA welcomes in the #1 scoring offense with extra rest that has won the L4 by an avg score of 36-17 covering 3. In that span Brady has avg'd 293 ypg (66%) with an 8-1 ratio and he's only had 2 games TY where he has thrown an int (ARZ/SEA). Belichick is 11-4 vs rookie QB's and is 18-6-1 ATS as a DIV AF. NE quality stat edges with the #1 and #27 units (+24 TO's) vs the Dolphins #26 and #21 units (-10 TO's). MIA has allowed a 7-1 ratio over the L6 games and have gone 4 straight games without a takeaway. While NE gives up yards by the truckload (3 straight over 400 yds) they have not lost the TO battle in any game TY. NE has also allowed a very palatable 7-8 ratio over the L5 games getting a huge boost thanks to CB Talib the L2 games who has stabilized the unit. In the NFL QB's are the dominating factor and we'll side with a rested Brady with a run game that has avg'd 133 ypg (4.4) the L5 games vs Tannehill (7-12 ratio) with a team that is 4-12 ATS at home off a SU win.

OTHER GAMES

New Orleans at ATLANTA - The Saints are now 5-6 after their 0-4 start with the losses at Den and to SF. The Falcons get a quick shot at redemption having lost 31-27 at NO 18 days ago becoming the last team without a loss. Can the Saints continue their turnaround and win and cover for a 5th straight time vs the Falcons? Or will Atlanta who is 0-3 in the Dome since '08 vs NO and 31-3 versus everyone else finally end the series domination? NFL Marquee's are 18-9 ATS 67% and this play is yours for \$12 through our office, \$9 on the NC Sports Debit Card system or on your Marquee 7-pack after Noon EST Thursday.

CHICAGO 27 Seattle 21 - If familiarity breeds success the Seahawks should do just fine as this is their 4th trip to Soldier Field in the L3Y winning both reg season games but dropping their 2010 playoff meeting. LY Caleb Hanie is in his 4th start replacing Cutler (IR) and in the 2H Seattle held Chicago to a TOTAL of 21 plays for 65 yards. The Seahawks were off a bye before LW's loss at Miami and were slow out of the gate going 3&out their first 4 drives before putting up 3 td's in their next 4. The Bears have seen their early division lead fade away after B2B losses to a pair of elite teams as Cutler was inj'd in the first and missed the second. In his return LW he was treated to a 25-3 HT lead so the offense turned very vanilla. While Chicago's offense has struggled at home their last 4 games (257 ypg) the D stepped it up and only allowed 45 points in their 4 wins. Both play similar D's so the edge goes to Cutler who practiced against it for years vs rookie Wilson facing a top 5 D with his 6-8 ratio on the road leading his team to just 16 ppg. Keep an eye on possible Seattle suspensions in their secondary.

GREEN BAY 31 Minnesota 17 - LY heading into December the Packers were undefeated with the division wrapped up. This year they are off B2B road games and if they beat the Giants they are tied with Chicago for the division lead. The Packers have taken 4 straight in the series winning by 19 ppg and LY here at Lambeau GB led 17-0 at HT before scoring 4 straight td's in the 2H. Packers GB DC Capers loves to dial up blitzes and this year they are #2 in sacks incl 12 in their 2 div games while LY they held Ponder to 205 ypg with only 44% completions. Rogers meanwhile dreams about purple as in his L3 games vs the Vikings he's thrown for 299 ypg, 76% completions and a not too shabby 11-0 ratio!! GB know how to protect their home field as they've covered 13 of 18 with 3 of those ATS losses when they were laying DD vs a non-div foe. We're by no means calling the Vikings quitters (yet) but it must be noted after their bye LY they dropped 6 of their L7 and while they are 6-5 after losing 3 of the L4 if they fall behind early we'll wait to see what happens.

San Francisco 24 ST LOUIS 9 - Earlier this season the 49ers had a B2B road trips and beat the NY Jets 34-0. Sound familiar? Just 3 weeks ago they hosted this same opponent as a 13 pt fav and lost, well tied, and the D will look for revenge after allowing not only a season high 458 yds but 181 yards over their season avg. While Kaepernick made his first start vs Chicago's #5 D he led SF to a 5 week high of 353 yards and LW followed it up with a 6 week high of 375 yards. While they're on the road for a second straight being in a Dome again will clearly aid the young QB. St Louis got their first road win of the season and while they matched a season high with 31 pts 2 td's came of pick 6's. The Rams won their first 3 at home vs WAS, SEA and ARZ but their last 2 home games much more represented the caliber of this opp (GB & NYJ) which they went 0-2 SU & ATS against. No problem backing a 49ers team that went into GB and won 30-22, into NY and beat the Jets 34-0, into Arizona on MN and won 24-3 and LW into the Superdome and won 31-21. And by the way our exclusive special team rankings has SF as our #2 unit while St Louis is our #30.

Carolina 21 KANSAS CITY 20 - The Panthers are off their 1st Monday Night'r since 2009 and those results are unknown. Heading into this season Carolina was an AF 4 times in the previous 4 years incl their '08 season when they were the #2 seed in the playoffs and now this may be the 3rd time they're in that role despite a 2-8 record. Clearly a tough 2 game road trip for Newton and

crew with the short week but at least they're traveling to KC. The Panthers have had a difficult road schedule taking on 4 teams that have combined for 28 wins yet they've covered 3 of 4 and have collectively outgained them by 55 ypg. The Chiefs have discovered 2 things and those are that Quinn isn't the one to guide your team (52.9 QBR, 0-3 ratio) and neither is Cassell (66.7 QBR, 6-12 ratio). The 2 have combined for an 8 game losing streak scoring only 10 ppg the L7 while not topping 300 yards the L6 games. Certainly can't back the Chiefs but also can't back the Panthers as an AF when the team is averaging just 18 ppg and lost all 3 outright as a fav TY.

DETROIT 31 Indianapolis 24 - The Lions are off another Thanksgiving loss but have covered 3 of the L4 afterwards. They played more than well enough to win vs HOU with the penalty on Schwartz nullifying a review on an obviously down RB Forsett td run. Both teams are statistically even with DET having the #2 and #15 units (-7 TO's) and IND having the #5 and #20 units (-14 TO's) but the Lions have played a top 10 sked TY while IND has played a bottom 5. While IND is a feel good playoff contender they have only played 1 team with a top 10 offense (NE) and 7 games vs teams ranked 17th or lower on offense. Luck has avg'd 276 ypg (61%) with a 6-6 ratio over the L6 games vs pass def ranked 21st or lower that have given up a combined 47 more tds than ints TY. DET secondary has its own issues (17-7 ratio) and while Suh's status is uncertain here the NE game showed that the Colts defense isn't built for a shoot out. DET has won the yardage battle in 9 games TY by an avg of 94 ypg and we'll call for the home team off a brutal loss to get the win here.

BUFFALO 27 Jacksonville 20 - Bills fans would certainly prefer it to be colder than the forecasted mid 40's but their happy to host another Florida teams after beating Miami here 2 games ago. Credit must be given to the Jaguars as they've not let up getting their second win of the season in beating Tennessee LW thanks to Henne stretching the field with six passes over 20 yards incl a 59 yd td pass. Jacksonville has covered all 5 of their road games with an amazing 3 of those going to OT. The Bills have moved the ball at home avg 370 ypg and 29 ppg but they are in a new situation as the last time they were a favorite of over 4 points was the 2009 season finale. While Henne has given the Jags a spark the last 2 games it was vs Houston in a bad situation and a Tennessee team off a bye with equal talent. Buffalo was listless vs Indy LW but now returns home and when facing a team they're expected to beat they've knocked off KC by 18, Cleveland by 10 and Miami by 5 pts. We'll call for the Bills by a td and see if the public overreacts to the Jags win.

DENVER 34 Tampa Bay 20 - Tampa Bay makes this trip with a 5-0 ATS road record but they were outgained by 224 ypg at the NYG and Dallas and haven't played an elite team such as this, since they became a formidable foe. On the road Tampa is avg 152 ypg and 5.1 ypc but none of those teams were ranked in the top 12 in rush D and combined their avg rank is #23. Denver's rush D will be their toughest opponent by far as they've allowed 77 ypg and 3.3 ypc. Freeman and the OL have been the true beneficiaries getting sacked only 9 times the L8 games but now have to face the league's top sack team led by Von Miller (14 sks). On the flip side it certainly spells trouble when your team is dead last in pass D and now you're facing a rejuvenated Peyton Manning who owns a 13-1 ratio at home. Weather won't be a factor with the forecast in the high 50's but the Bucs and their #32 schedule will be off an OT road game and a hard fought division loss and now playing in altitude.

Pittsburgh at BALTIMORE - Not many teams can say they've started 3 different QB's in their L3 games but Pittsburgh can. The Steelers turned the ball over 8 times and was -7 in TO's yet still only lost by 6 at Cleveland. Big Ben may be ready for this one and if not and a second straight week of #1 reps will do Batch wonders. Just 2 weeks ago when these two met Baltimore got to face a hobbled Leftwich who wouldn't have beaten RG III in a 100 yd dash with a 70 yard lead yet the Ravens still got outgained 311-200. The Ravens D continues to be overvalued as they now been outgained 6 of the last 7 games and LW at SD they had only 90 yds and 5 FD's in the 1H but the Chargers couldn't put them away. When you get a team that knows how to win (11 wins/yr the L5), has the better D (#1 vs #24), has triple revenge and is looking up in the standings you have a solid play. Add in the fact that the road team in Ravens division games are 14-3-1 ATS while Baltimore had to also travel back across country after playing 14 extra minutes make it stronger. We'll hold off on this one still the injury situation settles.

Cleveland 26 OAKLAND 24 - OAK beat CLE 24-17 LY as a 6.5 pt HF with a 329-268 yd edge but they are just 4-15 ATS as a HF while CLE is 6-2-1 ATS as an AD. While Cleveland would normally be at disadvantage traveling to the West Coast Oakland just lost at Cincy so that negates it. The Browns knocked off the Steelers for only the 2nd time in 18 games and despite having faced a 3rd string QB they still held them to a season low (242 yds) while holding each of their last 5 opponents under their season avg by 74 ypg. There's a new excitement amongst the Browns since the new ownership officially took over and that includes wins vs SD and Pittsburgh and in their 3 losses they led 13-0 at HT vs Dallas (outgained 320-311), led Baltimore 14-13 in the 4Q (outgained them 290-282) and got outgained by 2 yards in a 4 pt loss at Indy. Oakland started this season off with a 3-4 record but the defense has wilted with the leagues worst secondary (101.9 opp QBR) and they've allowed 42 ppg during their 4 game SU & ATS losing streak and on the season are allowing a 23-6 ratio (on record setting pace). We'll also back an team with something to play for vs a "here we go again" Raiders attitude which has led to a 4-17 ATS record as a fav incl 0-4 ATS TY.

SAN DIEGO 24 Cincinnati 20 - CIN is making only their 2nd road trip in the last 7 weeks. Their win last week gives them 3 straight and puts them at 6-5 keeping their playoff chance alive. If you check out the Bengals home/road splits you'd be impressed that they've outgained their opponents by 79 ypg but none of the D's ranked in the top half in the NFL (combined avg #23) while SD was #10 into this writing. SD meanwhile went into LW's Baltimore game having dropped 5 of 6 but the only opponent they didn't outgain in that stretch was a Denver squad that is playing the best football in the league (#4 off & #4 D). The Chargers are a complete head case as despite having the #25 off and #10 defense they are now 4-7 with their wins coming against teams that have a combined nine wins. The talent on the field still calls for the Chargers but any week they'll pull the plug and blow this team up. We'll call for SD by 4 but with some hesitation.

Philadelphia at DALLAS - If you were in Las Vegas this past spring and wanted to bet on the NFC Champion these 2 were listed #2 and #6 and now they've combined for 13 losses. Huge situational edge to Dallas off a Thanksgiving Day game while Philly was a HD to Carolina on Monday Night without Vick or McCoy. No matter who's under center for the Eagles you have to be concerned about the psyche of the entire team. Dallas however is 0-5 ATS at home TY and only 2-11 ATS as a div HF. We'll see how the Eagles played on MN and have either the side or total as the marquee after Noon EST gameday.

NY Giants at WASHINGTON - The Giants are off the Packers on Sunday Night and a loss would mean a 3 games losing streak. Washington meanwhile went into their bye with a 3 game losing streak but came out of it beating Philly and Dallas. If NY goes down there would be for a tie for first place. Earlier this year in RG III's first div game he led the Skins to 480 yards of offense but Manning responded with a 77 yd td pass to Cruz with 1:13 left for the win. Both the Monday Night Magic and Marquee will be available after Noon EST on Monday and we've already swept 4 times this season.

UNDERDOG PLAY OF THE WEEK

Over the past 30 years this play has been a reader favorite hitting 208-155.

CONNECTICUT (+6) over Cincinnati

The HT is 7-1 SU and 6-1 ATS incl 5 str wins by 16 ppg. The Bearcats are 6-2 vs the Huskies but have dropped 2 straight in Storrs by 24 and 21 pts. Conn is 3-1 ATS with their lone loss by 1/2 pt. LY Cincy got 2 def td's in the 1Q and led 28-6 at the half and 35-12 in the 4Q and won 35-27 (-7). Both tms come in off conf wins as Conn (+12) led L'ville for much of the gm (10-0 after 3Q's) but the Cards tied it with a td pass w/:21 left. After the tms traded scores in the 1st 2 OT's, Conn got an int in the EZ, then kicked a 30 yd FG for the win which gave us another Big Dog POW outright upset winner (+10'). The Huskies were outgained 401-241 and bkp QB McEntee did replace an inj'd Whitmer (CS) in the 4Q but both were ineffective going a comb 9-28-92-1-1. The Bearcats took adv of a beaten-up and unmotivated USF playing a 3rd string QB in their 27-10 (-14) win but still were outFD'd 22-18 as QB Kay, who replaced an inconsistent Legaux 3W ago has been inconsistent at best avg 224 ypg (59%) with a 3-2 ratio. Cincy is playing a 10th straight wk while Conn has had two byes in the last 5 weeks and should be a lot fresher. Conn has been -2' and +3' in their last two home finales but won SU by 21 and 18 pts. Conn is playing for a bowl here and we most certainly will take the home tm w/the def edge (#22-42) that has more on the line here.
