POST DRAFT "A" & "D" GRADES HITTING 82% OVER 3 YEARS!

The Post Draft Issue grades a team's offseason a little differently than most. The grades we put into Power Sweep predict whether a team's record will improve or decline for the upcoming season. We take EVERYTHING into account. Included in the analysis are coaching changes, the NFL Draft, Free Agent signings, Free Agent losses and even favorable or unfavorable schedules. The "A" & "D" grades have been extremely accurate over the years.

We spend a great deal of time and effort making these grades and while there was no list in '11 (work stoppage), here is a recap of the past 19 years as well as '09, '10, '12 and '13.

Last year we released a total of 8 teams which earned either an "A" or "D" grade. 7 of the 8 teams were correct including the 4 "A" teams all improving their record by an avg of 5.5 wins. This included KC (+9) and PHI (+6) who were the 2 most improved teams in the NFL LY. The 4 "D" teams went 3-0-1 incl ATL (-9) and MIN (-5.5). The only blemish in LY's article was IND whose last 3 wins came against HOU and JAX who both gave up playing at the end of yr while going for the #1 pick in the draft. They also beat a KC tm who already had a playoff berth clinched at the time of the game. Those last 3 wins allowed them to match their record from the year before.

These "A" and "D" are a huge help in determining which teams to bet on using the Vegas Over/Under season total. This year on every division page, you can see a last 3 year number for the Vegas Over/Under for each team. The Cincinnati Bengals actually lead the way as they have went "Over" their Vegas win total each of the last 3 years by a combined 8 wins.

Offense: It remains unclear where CIN is right now in their evaluation of QB Dalton who is in the final year of his rookie contract (0-3 playoffs 1-6 ratio). Expect a more run oriented system under new OC Hue Jackson as while they lose their starting C and a slot WR, they have plenty of depth on hand. Letting Dalton play out 2014 looks to be the shrewd move here.
Grade: EVEN

Defense: The Bengals got a steal in the 1st Rnd with Dennard sliding all the way to #24 as many scouts had him rated as the #1 DB. The only key loss to LY's #3 overall def is DE Johnson (replacement drafted in 3rd Rnd). While DT Atkins (ACL) returns the Bengals will miss DC Zimmer in 2014.
Grade: DOWN

Overview: The Bengals once again stumbled in the playoffs and have now failed to win a post-season game since 1990. Their 2014 schedule is tougher (early bye) and their 4 road games in 5 weeks will be huge late in the year. CIN will be hard pressed to keep their title this year.

Offense: Balanced offssn for the PIT off as they brought in a few veterans and lost a few in the process, most notably WR Sanders to DEN. PIT added a lot of speed TY but their best pickup was the addition of Mike Munchak as the OL Coach to help out Roethlisberger.
Grade: EVEN

Defense: The Steelers defense has been on a slide the L3Y as the Cowher drafted players age out. PIT added the athletic Shazier to put some speed in the LB unit but the real issue will be who generates the pass rush at the OLB spots. The Steelers secondary has it's own problems and the defense isn't as feared as it used to be for a reason.
Grade: EVEN

Overview: The Steelers organization is one of the best in the NFL as they stick to a system and don't overreact to bad seasons. While we give the team an even grade on both off and def TY, they have a late season bye and get 3 of their L5 at home in the cold.

The loss of OT Oher is not that big a deal with the signing of Ctr Zuttah. BAL must improve upon LY's 30th ranked rush off (poor OL LY) esp with Rice's susp upcoming.

Defense: BAL lost a few solid players in FA but that's more than offset by the addition of 1st rounder Mosley and 2nd rounder Jernigan to shore up the middle. With the Ravens it's not the players it's the system and Newsome makes sure they have the players for it.

Offense: The expected loss of Josh Gordon is a big blow to an otherwise promising offssn by the Browns. CLE will be one of the most run heavy units in the NFL behind a top 10 OL as they buy time for Manziel to get up to speed.
Grade: EVEN

Defense: With the addition of 1st Rnd pick Gilbert, the Browns have a deep and strong secondary which was reinforced by FA pickup SS Whitner from SF. This def is deep on all 3 levels and Dansby's tenacity offsets the leadership loss of ILB Jackson (IND). There is a lot to like here esp if Mingo steps up in his soph year.
Grade: UP

Overview: The Browns have had the biggest image boost of any tm in the NFL this offssn under new GM Farmer and getting an expected top 10 pick from BUF in 2015 is even better. What remains to be seen is how Manziel's intangibles/ and style of play will translate into the NFL. He definitely brings excitement.
