LW La Tech & SMiss comb'd for -1 yd rush (LT 30, SM -31). SM led 7-3 at HT but LT outscored them 28-13 in the 2H. The Bulldogs are now a perfect 4-0 in CUSA play and they are +23 ppg and +89 ypg in conf play (WKU is +1 ppg, -43 ypg). Their opp WKU is off a very misleading 66-51 win (-13') over ODU LW. They key play happened with ODU down 56-51. They had a 1st & Goal, open WR in the end zone, but the ball slipped out of QB Heinicke's hand & was returned 96 yds for a TD, a dreaded 14 pt swing. LT has a massive D edge (#51-126), WKU is 1-3 ATS as an AD and we get value off WKU's misleading win LW. La Tech rolls again.

FORECAST: LOUISIANA TECH by 14

3★ North Carolina (+) over MIAMI, FL - This has been an underdog series. The dog is not only 8-2 ATS but they've had 5 outright upsets in that span. NC won 3 in a row SU from '07-'09 but UM has gone 3-1 SU/ATS the last 4 meetings. LY was a Thur night game and NC was +9' at home vs #10 undefeated Miami and should have won as they blew a 10-pt 4Q lead in a 27-23 loss. LTH NC was -7' and won 20-14. This is NC's 3rd AG in 4 wks while UM had a bye 2 wks ago and has a bye next wk. Both tms come in red hot as the Canes ran over VT 30-6 (-3) piling up 364 rush yds, the most ever vs a Frank Beamer VT tm. NC opened LY 1-5 and went 6-1 down the stretch and now could be duplicating that TY as after starting 2-4, they have won their L/2 gms incl an upset over UVA LW 28-27 (+7). You have to give it to the aggressive Fedora as after NC gets a TD with 4:05 left to take the lead, he goes for the surprise outside kick & runs out the clock. The Tar Heels have covered 3 str and clearly have backdoor potential here (remember only lost to ND by 7).

FORECAST: MIAMI, FL by 4

3★ EASTERN MICHIGAN (+) over Central Michigan - 92nd meeting, played every yr s/72. This is part of the battle for the Michigan MAC Champ. EM was 4-1 SU/ATS from '04-'08 but CM is now 4-1 SU/ATS the L5. LY EM trailed 21-0 but cut the deficit to 21-10 at HT. CM opened the 2H w/a 84 yd KR td, got a 44 yd td run & in the 4Q ret'd an int 75 yds for a td in their 42-10 (-17). LW CM had a 341-271 yd edge vs Buff. Tied at 14, CM drove 98/16pl for a TD w/8:08 left. Despite the win, they did suffer a huge loss as RB Rawls was hurt in the 1Q (knee, CS) but Saylor Lavallii did have 80 rush yds and 2 td's (not as explosive though). EM, on the other side, led N III 17-14 into the 4Q and were only outgained 386-381. QB Bell passed for 124 & rushed for 133 but they lost 28-17 (+20). They have played much better at home TY (-49 ypg, -320 ypg away) and we ? how potent that CM offense can be if Rawls can't go here.

FORECAST: Central Michigan by 9

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ KANSAS ST over Oklahoma St - While Ok St is 5-2 SU the last 7 meetings, Kansas St is 8-2 ATS and the HT is 7-1 SU (-4.4 ATS). LY OSU was -13' at home and fortunate to escape with a 4 pt win. While KSt may be in a bit of a flat spot here off OU and Texas and have a huge gm vs TCU on deck, Ok St is on their 3rd road gm in 4 wks. KSt is also 8-2 ATS as a B12 HF and we'll say it again, OSU is like LY's TT team who started 7-0 and beat up the weakest B12 teams early and then faltered big time down the stretch (lost 5 str SU/ATS). The Cowboys who started 5-1 have now lost B2B gms by a combined 57 pts and Kansas St has already beaten the likes of TT and Texas by a combined 55 pts at home earlier TY. Wildcats in a route.

FORECAST: KANSAS ST by 21

2★ Purdue (+) over NEBRASKA - PU is fresh off a bye while NU is playing a 3rd str wk. LY we used Neb as a 3★ Key Selection on the road -13'. The crowd appeared 50/50 with a lot of red and NU simply dominated. They led 21-0 at the half with a 205-89 yd edge and got a td with :50 left to make it 44-0 but PU got a 55 yd td pass with :39 left to avoid the shutout 44-7. This is Purdue's 1st ever trip to Lincoln. They have covered 5 of their L/6 gms and should have upset Minny in their L/gm (led 38-29). The offense has come alive w/Appley under Chr as they have topped 30 pts in each of their L/3 gms. The Neb offense is avg 41 ppg and 515 ypg thanks to RB Abdullah who had a schl-rec 341 all-purp yds in their 42-24 win (-20') over Rutgers LW. Purdue is on a 7-3 run as an AD (2-0 TY) & have covered 4 str away from home and we think they are fully capable of getting the back door here.

FORECAST: NEBRASKA by 17

OTHER GAMES

Thursday, October 30th

Troy at GEORGIA SOUTHERN - GS is just 3-10 in the series but won 3 of the L/4 incl their last mtg 24-21 in '95 (IAA playoffs). These two tms come in on opposite ends of the spectrum as Ga So is 6-2 SU/ATS in their 1st yr of FBS play while Troy is 1-7 SU/4-4 ATS in the LY under HC Blakeney. The nation's #1 rush attack is avg 402 ypg (7.4) w/400 rush td's while Troy is all'g 245 rush ypg (5.7). However, Troy will be in their largest conf underdog role since they joined the Sun Belt in '04 (3-0 ATS as SBC DD dog L/2 yrs) and we'll ask again like LW, does Troy have any fight left?

Florida St at LOUISVILLE - FSU is 12-2 vs UL but lost the LTH ('02) 26-20 (-14'). FSU led 20-13 into the 4Q but all'd a gm tying 4Q td eventually losing in OT. The defending champs come in on a 23-gm win streak after their thrilling 31-27 win (-10) over ND but they are just 1-6 ATS TY. UL is 6-2 SU/5-3 ATS TY and in their L/gm got back AA WR Devante Parker (132 yds). While not as dominant as LY, the Noles have a found a way to make plays when it counts each gm during their streak. Can they do it again here?

Friday, October 31st

Tulsa at MEMPHIS - UM has lost 4 str (all as CUSA foes) incl a 48-7 loss (+9) in the L/meeting ('10). The 41 pt MOV was the series largest (24 gms). Incl bowls, Tulsa is 6-1 SU/7-0 ATS s/'91 at the Liberty Bowl. The Golden Hurricane come in off a bye and are just 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS as they have had a couple of tough luck losses (+31 ypg in AAC play). Memphis is 4-3 SU/5-1-1 ATS off a dominating win over SMU 48-10 (-23). While Mem is clearly the better tm, they haven't been this large of a conf HF s/'08 and Tulsa is avg 506 ypg in AAC play.

Cincinnati at TULANE - From 1996-'04 these schools were both CUSA members. The Green Wave are 11-3 all-time vs the Bearcats but the L/gm was in '02 at the Superdome where TU won 35-17 (+4). Cincy comes in off B2B wins/covers but QB Kiel was hurt (ribs) and missed the 2H of the win over USF L/Friday. Tulane is off B2B covers themselves and are 7-0 ATS as a conf HD w/5 outright upsets. With Kiel's inj situation unknown at presstime, we'll pass on this matchup until Gameday.

Saturday, November 1st

† Notre Dame by 17 over Navy - Landover, MD. You would think the situation favors ND here as they had bye LW to get ready for the option but LY were in an even better situation as they had played AF the week before to get ready for the option and Navy's offense shredded them for 28 FD and 331 rush (4.8). ND beat Navy 43 str yrs but then Navy won 3 out of 4 from '07-'10. Brian Kelly mentioned they'd never forget the 35-17 loss to Navy in '10 and beat them 56-14 and 50-10 the next 2Y but LY was -16' at home and Navy was SOD at the ND31 at the end with ND clinging to a 38-34 win. The Irish are off the devastating 31-27 (+10) loss to FSU where they had a 470-323 yd edge but were rightly called for offensive PI in the final seconds. The loss did not knock them out of playoff contention and it will be interesting to see if they take their frustrations out here. Navy got their act together LW in a 41-31 win (-8') over SJSt as a finally healthy Keenan Reynolds ran for a career-high 251 yds. Since '94 there's been a pretty simple formula in this series. If you play on ND when neutral or away and against ND when they are at home, your record in the 20 matchups would be 17-3 ATS.

VIRGINIA TECH by 7 over Boston College - VT had won 4 in a row SU in the series until LY's upset when they had a 446-289 yd edge but were -4 in TO's and they lost 34-27 (-4) on the road.

BC has now covered 3 in a row ATS. VT is 13-5 SU in this series and have indeed, gotten revenge after each of BC's 4 victories with VT winning by an avg of 35-10. The Hokies come in struggling at 4-4 SU and have gone 1-5 ATS after their upset win over Ohio St. LW they needed a 14 yd TD pass w/1:30 left to keep alive their 250 game scoring streak (1995) in their 30-6 loss (+3) to Miami. The Canes 364 rush yds were the most ever vs a Beamer D. On the other side, BC held WF to 6 yds of offense in the 1H and led 23-3 before WF got a 75 yd TD drive, BC fumbled the KO and WF got another td to only lose 23-17 (-14). The situation favors VT here as BC is on their 3rd AG in 4 wks while VT had a bye and two Thurs Night gms so they do get a couple extra days to prep, have a bye on deck and are playing with legit revenge.

East Carolina by 3 over TEMPLE - Temple is 1-5 s/'87 vs E Carolina. L/meeting ('95) the Owls lost 32-22 (+18). While the Pirates come in 6-1 SU and in the Top 20, Vegas linesmakers have caught up to them after their B2B upsets over VT and N Car. They have failed to cover 3 str gms all as a large fav incl LW. They were favored by 4 TD's, but were tied 21-21 mid 4Q vs 1-6 UConn until scoring the final 10 pts. Temple is off B2B DD losses on the road vs two of the better tms in the AAC and LW were outgained 466-182. On the ssn they are now -17 ypg vs the #109 sked while ECar is +198 ypg vs the #114 sked. However, Temple is dangerous here and remember LY they nearly knocked off a Top 20 AAC tm in UCF at home (losing 39-36, +17').

Ucf by 14 over CONNECTICUT - LY was the first meeting. UCF was off their big win over Lville but dominated. We used UCF as the Early Bird POW (get it FREE every week on Mondays by calling 1-347-677-1700) and UCF led 45-10 at the half with a 338-90 yd edge. They scored on their first 2 drives of the 2H in a 62-17 (covered by 3 td's) win. Don't look now but LY's Fiesta Bowl champs have quietly won 5 str gms after starting 0-2. LW was arguably their best gm of the ssn as they beat Temple 34-14 (-9') and had a dominating 466-182 yd edge. On the flip side, Conn after starting 0-6 ATS finally got their 1st cover of the ssn in a 31-21 loss (+28) to E Car. Their offense "exploded" for 397 yds (avg'd just 256 ypg prior) but they still are only avg 79 rush ypg (2.4) and will be taking on a UCF rush D all'g just 93 ypg (3.1) in AAC play. Knights win 6th straight.

Wisconsin by 17 over RUTGERS - First meeting. UW is 26-27 SU in B10 AG's s/'01 (have dropped 2+ 10 of L/13 yrs). Rutgers is facing their 3rd straight big, physical tm and after losing to Ohio St 56-17 (+21), they fell to Neb 42-24 (+20') LW. More importantly, they could have lost QB Nova for an extended period as he was inj'd in the 2Q LW (knee, CS). Bkp Laviano was just 4-7-49 in the 2H. On the flip side, Wisc moved to 9-0 SU/ATS after a reg ssn bye as we easily cashed our Top Weekly LPS and a 3★ on these pages in their 52-7 win (-10). UW's DL was finally healthy (527-102 yd edge) & led 52-0 before Maryland drove 73 yds in 8 plays getting a TD w/57 left to avoid the shutout. Rutgers' small speedy defense gives up 5.6 ypc in B10 play and now must slow down Wisky's massive OL that paves the way for a run attack that is avg 338 ypg (7.2).

SYRACUSE by 3 over NC State - NCSt was 2-0 SU/ATS upsetting #13 Syr in '97 (+25) and #11 Syr in '98 (+12). LY the upset streak cont'd as this time NCSt was -6' at home and Syr beat them 24-10. Situational edge to NCSt here as they are fresh off a bye while SU plays an 8th str game incl ND, Lville, FSU and Clem in 4 of the L5W. The Wolfpack are at a cross roads (started 4-0, lost L/4) while the Cuse are 3-5 and off a 16-6 loss (+14') to Clemson LW. The gm was a bit misleading as Clem had a 23-10 FD edge but settled for a 18-yd FG in the 3Q & ended the game taking a knee at the Syr 8-yd line. NCSt is 3-7-1 as an AD but the Orange are just 1-4 ATS as a HF. Both tms are positive ypg on the yr (Cuse +17, NC St +12) but Cuse have played the tougher sked (#30 vs #72).

PITTSBURGH by 3 over Duke - Duke is playing w/legit revenge and is fresh off a bye while Pitt just tangled with VT and GT. LY the flu swept thru Duke the wk prior with 15 ply's missing part. Pitt's tremendous WR duo of Boyd and Street comb'd for 320 yds and it looked like it would be a blowout. Pitt was up 51-28 but Duke battled back & when a snap went through Pitt's P's hands, Duke went 30/4 for a td w/3:43 left to get within 3. Pitt ran the clock and escaped with the non-covering 58-55 (-4) win. LW Pitt lost FIVE fumbles (4 on their 1st 6 snaps) in the 1st Q vs GT! Their #4 D allowed 615 total yds and they lost 56-28 (-3). Despite Duke's 2-1 mark in league play, they are getting outgained by 134 ypg! For the ssn despite their 6-1 record, they are just +22 ypg and have played just the #90 sked while Pitt is +90 ypg vs the #85 sked. Duke is all'g 214 rush ypg away from home and that's not good news facing Pitt's power rush attack.

Maryland by 3 over PENN ST - The last & only time PSt lost to Maryland was in 1961 (tied in 1989). Penn St won 70-7 (-18) in the last game ('93) which ironically was PSt's 1st yr in the B10 and now the Terps are in their 1st yr. Overall, the Nittany Lions are 35-1-1 all-time vs the Terps. LW we went against both of these tms and MD was destroyed 52-7 (+10) as Wisc had a 527-102 yd edge as we cashed our Top Weekly LPS and a 3★ on these pages. On the other side, Ohio St led PSt 17-0 at HT. The gm turned around on a 40 yd IR TD for the Lions and despite the fact PSt did not cross OSU's 44-yd line until 12:00 were left in the 4Q, they would take the gm to 2OT before losing 31-24 (+14). Penn St's anemic run gm had just 16 rush yds and now they're avg just 46 ypg (1.5) in B10 play TY. They will be taking on a MD def that has managed 4 sks vs both Iowa and OSt. Edsall is on a 14-6 ATS run as HC as an AD and we wonder how much PSt will have left in the tank after such an emotional gm LW.

APPALACHIAN ST by 7 over Georgia St - First Meeting. Two of the SBC's bottom feeders. 2-5 App St comes in off a bye after a shocking blowout win over Troy on the road 53-14 (-7). They put up 441 rush yds (8.1) which isn't good news for Ga St fans as they are coming off a 69-31 loss (+17') to Ga Southern as they all'd 613 rush yds (9.7) and are all'g 341 rush ypg in SBC play TY. Despite that mismatch at the LOS, we can't back them here as this will be the first time App St has been a HF vs an FBS opp (1-1 vs FCS tms TY, incl an upset loss) while Ga St is 8-3 as an AD incl a perfect 3-0 TY (SBC loses by 3 pts each on road). We'll call it at the line.

Air Force by 4 over ARMY - AF has dominated the series and is 15-2 SU and 13-4 ATS. After AF's last 3 losses to Army, they've rebounded with big wins 24-0 in '97, 43-7 in '06 and LY were playing with revenge after Army's 41-21 home win in '12. AF was starting 4th string QB Romine and won 42-28 (-1) at home. LTH (AF's first loss in West Point s/'96), the Falcons trailed 35-7 into the 4Q but cut the deficit to 14 w/the ball. AF fmbd and Army rec in the EZ w/2:50 left ending any comeback chance. Both tms come in off byes. After a 2-10 ssn, the Falcons are one of the MIP tms in the country TY at 5-2. They are avg 426 ypg on offense but are much more balanced than the other service academies as they are avg 152 pass ypg. They allow a respectable 145 rush ypg (4.1) on D considering they have already played 2 option tms (allowed 251 rush to Navy and 367 to NM). Army is avg 319 rush ypg (5.6) and only 77 ypg pass. Despite not facing an option tm yet, they are all'g 176 rush ypg (5.2). Army is a much better tm at home (+4 ypg) than away (-88 ypg) and AF is 0-5 ATS as an AF w/3 outright upsets losses. AF claims the CIC Trophy but this goes down to the wire.

IOWA by 4 over Northwestern - NW is now 6-3 SU /ATS and there are rumors that Pat Fitzgerald hates Iowa (broke his leg as a player against Iowa). Both teams are off a loss and off a bye as NW travels here for a 2nd straight season after losing 13-10 as a 3' pt road fav LY (home team 4-0 SU/ATS). Fitzgerald is as intense as any HC but perhaps they lose something during a bye week as the Wildcats have lost 6 straight the game after a bye covering only 2 of those (+9 & +10). Slight technical edges to the Wildcats here as Iowa is 5-11 as a HF while NW is 14-7 as a AD. Tough to lay much here considering Iowa is only outsourcing their foes by 5 ppg TY and the only gm they won by more than a score, they were playing an Indy tm playing a converted LB at QB in the 2H due to inj.

Texas by 4 over TEXAS TECH - UT is 13-2 SU/10-5 ATS. LTH UT was +6' and never trailed. LY on Thanksgiving, UT led 20-10 at the half with TT's only scores on a fake punt, which went 51 yds for a td and a fg after roughing the punter and QB pen's. UT won 41-16 (-4') at home. Heading into LW the Texas offense had improved every week from 258 vs BYU to 512 vs Iowa St, but they did get shutout vs KSt 23-0 (+10). Their D is still legit as it is all g 92 ypg less than what their opp are avg. On the other side, TT has had one solid performance all yr (3 pt loss to WV) and LW they were steamrolled 82-27 (+23) vs TCU all g 785 yds. Their D is all g 92 ypg more than what their opp are avg (#115 in country) and on offense, they lost their QB Webb (ankle, CS) which is huge considering they only have 1 other scholarship QB and he's a true fresh. We'll take the road team here w/the huge D edge (#9-111) and look for QB Swoopes and Co to get back in gear.

BAYLOR by 38 over Kansas - In '07 UK destroyed BU 58-10 (-26'). The last 4 meetings have been all Baylor as they've won by 30 ppg going 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS. The good news if you're a Kansas backer is that you went 2-0-1 ATS the 3 games prior to your bye (all under interim HC Bowen). The bad news is that this week you're facing a Baylor team that A) is also off a bye B) is 19-3 ATS at home C) has failed to cover B2B gms (incl getting upset in L/gm vs WV) and hasn't dropped 3 straight ATS in 4 seasons and finally E) is embarrassed that it allowed 58 pts in their first conf game in their new stadium. Add it all up and the Bears (+268 ypg #1 in country) get back on track here despite having that huge gm vs OU on deck.

Western Michigan by 6 over MIAMI, OH - The Broncos are 9-3 s/'88 incl 3 str wins (two by 3 pts or less). LTH ('11, also the L/meeting) WM won 24-21 (+1'). Miami is much improved under their first year HC Martin. After suffering 21 str defeats, they are 2-2 SU/3-1 ATS the L4 wks and are -50 ypg TY (-258 ypg LY). They are playing a 10th straight week but are home for a second straight after their 10-3 win (-6') over Kent St. The Broncos are also much improved TY as after going 1-11 SU LY, they can clinch bowl w/a win here and they have covered 7 str gms after their 42-21 (-1) SU win over Ohio LW. Despite being a dog in all but 2 games WM has outgained every foe, sans VT, thanks to an offense avg 188 ypg & 5.0 ypc rushing and QB Zach Terrell who is comp (87-118, 74%) with a 8-3 ratio vs conf foes. The Broncos haven't been in this large of a conf AF role s/they lost outright to EM 14-10 (-12) in '11 and we'll call this near the line.

MISSISSIPPI by 3 over Auburn - The loser of this one will have an uphill climb in the CFB playoff and SEC West chase. Auburn is 4-1 SU/ATS but the HT is 3-0 SU/ATS L3Y. LTH AU led 17-14 and only trailed 24-20 after 3Q's. Ole Miss would go on to score 17 4Q pts limiting AU to just -1 yd on 10 plays in the 41-20 win (-5). LY UM trailed 27-9 but cut the deficit to 5 w/8:29 left. UM went just 6 yds on 12pl their L/3 poss in the 30-22 (-3) loss. Both tms have played tough skeds and both are close as Miss is +113 ypg vs the #3 sked while Aub is +134 ypg vs the #5 sked. The Rebs fell to LSU 10-7 (-3) LW as HC Freeze had some interesting gm management at the end (decided against FG, QB Wallace throws int) but they did allow 264 rush yds. Aub faced a S Car tm LW that had nothing to lose (huge dog) and played like it as they converted 5 of 5 on 4th down including 4 in their own territory & recovered an onside kick. Auburn did get the 42-35 win (-19). Aub is 2-0 ATS as an AD w/a outright upset under Malzahn (4-12 prior) but Ole Miss counters with Freeze being 8-3-1 as a HF. This one goes to the wire.

MISSOURI by 4 over Kentucky - Mizzou is 2-0 both SU/ATS and in '12 here they were -14 and won 33-10. LY Mizzou led 28-3 at HT with a 252-105 yd edge and would cruise 48-17 (-14). LW Mizzou had a 385-240 yd edge vs Vandy who was st'g their 4th diff QB TY. However, it was just 17-14 when Mizzou got a 25 yd TD pass w/just 2:05 left. Despite the 14 pt loss to Miss St LW, we came away impressed w/UK as they are only getting outgained by 28 ypg in SEC play while Mizzou is -77 ypg. UK, however, has dropped 18 str SEC road gms (4-13 ATS w/one NL) and this is a tough stretch for them off LSU/#1 Miss St w/UGA on deck. For the yr, despite their 6-2 record, the Tigers are -20 ypg (UK +48).

MISSISSIPPI ST by 10 over Arkansas - Ark is off a 3 gm home stand and only had UAB LW with a bye on deck. Miss St did have a bye 2 wks ago and only has UTM on deck. Two years ago here Ark trailed 17-14 at the half but had 4 2H TD and were walloped 45-14 (+4'). LY Ark was at home and in a tie game, fmb'ld at the MSU9 with 5:22 left. MSU did miss a 42 yd fg w/18 left but won in OT 24-17 (-1). MSU had a 488-339 yd edge. There's only been 1 upset in this series the L13Y and Ark is 15-4 SU in this series. The HT is 5-2 SU/ATS. Miss St is on an overall 10-1-1 ATS run dating back to LY after their 45-31 win (-14) over KY LW. On the other side, Ark rolled to 35-0 HT lead LW and would cruise 45-17 (-26') over UAB. Miss St is playing in front of their home crowd as the #1 tm in the country for the 1st time in tm history and while they are 7-1 ATS as an SEC HF the L5Y, it's tough laying too much w/a tm that features the worst D in the SEC (all g 440 ypg).

TEXAS A&M by 35 over ULM - A&M is 2-0 incl a 54-14 win (-23) in the last game ('07). ULM has lost both previous mtg's by a comb 85-31. At the start of the year this could have been a trap game between Alabama and Auburn but that won't be the case with the Aggies reeling after 3 straight losses and 4 straight ATS losses. In their L/gm Kevin Sumlin was shutout for the 1st time in his HC career as they were embarrassed 59-0 (+13') vs Bama. On the other side, ULM was in control holding Texas St to 79 yds in the 1H. They led 15-0 in the 3Q & 18-7 with 7:00 left in the 4Q. Tex St got a 4th & 4, 40 yd TD and another TD to win 22-18 but we still easily cashed our College Totals LPS GOM on the UNDER. ULM has now failed to cover in 6 str gms and could rest some players here as they have more important conf gms on deck. Look for the Aggies to get back on track here.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 3 over Byu - LY was their first meeting. BYU was -24 at home. The Cougars led 37-10 after 3Q and MT was int'd in the EZ and SOD at the BYU 7 with BYU putting some of the str's back on the field late to preserve the cover. Just a month ago, BYU was 4-0 relaxing on their bye week (some knucklehead analysts were proj an easy path to 12-0) However, after their QB Hill was KO'd for the year, they've lost 4 straight (6 str ATS) including a 15 pt loss as a 20 pt fav and a 7 pt loss as a 12 pt fav. In their L/gm we cashed a 2★ LPS on the OVER as they lost to Boise 55-30 (+6'). Boise had a 637-322 yard edge. A disadvantage for being an independent is traveling to Orlando 3 gms ago, traveling back across county to face your in-state rival, traveling to the Blue Turf and then back across county to Tennessee here. On the flip side, MT is coming off a bye after beating UAB 34-22 (+1) and they have a bye on deck. Look for MT to continue the Cougs' woes here.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 6 over Tennessee - SC is playing with legitimate revenge here. UT is also playing their 6th str game and 2nd AG in 3 wks coming of a physical test vs Bama. Both teams have a bye on deck. LY SC was in their 2nd gm of a tough 3 gm road trip and were upset 23-21 (-7'). UT had not beaten a ranked foe s/'09 but knocked off #11 SC. The HT is 6-1 SU but the visitor is 13-3-1 ATS and SC is 1-4 ATS L5. LW Bama led Tenn 27-0 but bkp QB Dobbs (19-31-192) helped get it to 34-20. Bama did fumb'l at the 1 going in for a front door cover late. On the other side, SCar and HC Spurrier had nothing to lose at Auburn. They went 5 of 5 on 4th down including converting 4 in their own territory & recovered an onside kick but it wasn't good enough in the 42-35 loss (+19). Both tms need a win here if they have solid bowl aspirations, and while S Car is 0-4 as a HF being outright upset 2x's, Butch Jones is 2-5 as an AD here and overall UT is on a 4-10 ATS run as an AD.

† **Georgia by 17 over Florida** - Jacksonville, FL. UF HC Muschamp is a UGA grad and was 0-4 vs UF as a UGA player and now is 0-3 vs UGA as a UF HC making him 0-7 in the series. The team with the bye edge usually wins but this year they both come in off a bye. UGA has now won 3 in a row SU (+77 ypg). LY both came in unranked for the first time s/1926. UGA jumped out to a 23-3 HT lead but UF rallied to 23-20. UGA took over with 8:17 left in the game, went on a 67/15 drive to run out the clock (-3). Nine of the L/12 (incl the L4Y) were been decided by 8 pts or less but it's tough seeing that TY considering UF is in the miss and in their L/gm somehow found a way to lose 42-13 (-5') despite holding Mizzou to under 120 yds of offense (4 non-off td's). In fact, in the last 10 years teams that allow 120 yards or less are 147-2 SU in their games. The 2 losses BOTH belong to Florida under Muschamp. On the other side, the Bulldogs are rolling w/o RB Gurley (could be back here) and have scored at least 34 pts in every gm TY. Bulldogs get their largest MOV in this series s/'97.

Usc by 14 over WASHINGTON ST - USC is playing with legitimate revenge as LY their season started to go South when -15' at home, they missed 2 fg's then passed up on a fg and went for it and were SOD. They ended up losing 10-7 at home (Wazzu also got a 70 IR td right before HT). That loss LW snapped an 8Y win streak by USC (6-2 ATS). The visitor is actually 11-6 ATS in this series. USC is on their 3rd AG in 4 wks but does have a bye on deck. WSU had a bye 2 wks ago and is at home for a 3rd str wk. LW USC led 21-17 and went for it on 4th & 2 (passing up 45 yd FG). They got a FD but replays showed WR Agholor stepped the OOB and Utah went 73/11 getting a TD w/08 left to deal USC another last second loss. On the other side, Wash St was down 31-0 & 52-16 vs Zona but had the ydg edge because of 3 late td drives to "only" lose by 22. Considering the Trojans have bounced back strong after their prev 2 losses TY, we'll call for them to do it again here and we grab some extra value considering LW's misleading results.

OREGON by 14 over Stanford - UO is playing with legit revenge and catching Stanford on the road for the 4th time in 6 wks. In '10 and '11 the Ducks offense ran up, around and through SU's D putting up 52 and 53 pts. The L2Y SU's D controlled the game holding the Ducks to 14 pts in Autzen winning 17-14 in '12 and LY actually shutout UO in the first 3Q's leading 23-0 before the Ducks gained the majority of their yds and all of their 20 pts when the game was seemingly out of reach. The Ducks are back healthy and have now won and covered 3 str after LW's 59-41 (-17') win over Cal that cashed us a Fri Night Marquee on the OVER. While Mariota threw his 1st int of the ssn, he still has 24 td passes and 5 more on the ground. On the other side, Stanford dropped out of Top 25 for the 1st time in 4 yrs & then had their best gm of the year w/a 38-14 win (-13') over Oreg St as they had a 438-221 yd edge. Their D is all g just 251 ypg TY but ND and Ariz St both topped 350 in wins over the Cardinal and Oreg's offense is better than that. Oreg hasn't dropped 2 HG's in the same ssn s/'07 and we'll call for them to get revenge here.

Oklahoma by 17 over IOWA ST - OU has won 15 in a row SU in this series (7-2 ATS), winning the last 9 by 10+ pts. LTH OU was -12 and won 35-20 cashing us a 4★ Key Selection on these pages and a 4★ LPS. LY OU was -23' at home. OU, despite coming in off a loss to Baylor and figured to be angry, had just 1 FD and 25 yds in the 1Q and trailed 7-0. They got a 90 yd PR td w/1:09 left in the half to tie it at 10, which was the play of the game and OU rolled 48-10. Both teams come in fresh off a bye. Despite having a 148-yd edge, the Sooners fell to Kansas St 31-30 (-7) as they missed a chip-shot FG, had an xp blk'd, threw an int in the EZ and KSt had a 5-yd IR td. Ist only lost to Texas 48-45 (+12) in their L/outing. Stoops is 31-2 SU (22-10 but 0-2 L2Y ATS) off a LOSS! While they have Baylor on deck, look for them to rebound here.

MICHIGAN by 7 over Indiana - Mich is 32-1 SU in this series incl 18 str wins. IU's last win came in Ann Arbor in 1967. UM is only +30 ypg the last 3 meetings but does get IU at home for a 2nd str yr. LY UM set a school rec with 751 yds while Indy had 572 (1323 yds offense). UM led 49-47 mid-4Q and Indy had the ball but was int'd and ret'd 30 yds to the 5. UM would go onto win 63-47 (-9') in a gm closer than the final. TY IU is fresh off a bye and UM just played rival Mich St. The Wolverines were outgained 446-186 in the 35-11 loss (+17) and they have showed some bumps and bruises after a physical gm vs "Lil Brother" as they've gone 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS the wk after. We might be calling for the upset but Indy will be st'g a 175-lb true frosh QB here (5-15 11 yds vs MST and they lost 56-17) and UM has a legit D despite all the other struggles surrounding the program.

GEORGIA TECH by 3 over Virginia - This has been pretty easy. Pick the home tm as it is now 16-3 SU, 15-3-1 ATS. However, GT is 5-1 SU/4-1-1 ATS L6Y and GT's option has avg 393 ypg rush (6.6 ypc). LY GT was -10 on the road. VA had a 32-18 FD edge and forced 5 GT TO's but somehow lost by 10. GT had 3 RB's top 100 yds rushing (Laskey, Sims, Godhigh) which had not happened since 1950. Both these tms are off somewhat misleading gms as UVA led 14-0 (141-5 yds) early but NC got a TD with 4:05 left to take a 28-27 lead then recovered a surprise onside kick & ran out the clock. LW GT's opp Pitt lost FIVE fumbles in the 1st Q and GT roared to a 28-0 lead. They did end up with 615 yds vs the #4 total D in the country. GT is 1-3 TY as a HF being outright upset once. LW's results give us some added value here and UVA is +74 ypg TY vs the #46 sked while GT is +53 ypg vs the #65 sked.

Arkansas ST by 6 over IDAHO - ASt is 4-1 SU but 3-2 ATS dropping the L2. Interestingly, the spread from '01-'04 when these two were in conf play, was 5', 3', 1', 2' and the dog pulled the outright upset each time. LY with ID as an Ind, ASt was -26' at home but only won 48-24. ASt led 31-7 in the 3Q but ID got back to 31-24. ASt got a 21 yd fg w/6:19 left, 41-24 then went 73/7 for a td w/2:39 left to win by 24. ASt did lose their last trip here back in '04, 45-31 (-2'). Both tms come in off byes here, while ID is 1-6 SU TY they're also 5-2 ATS only getting outgained by 46 ypg. In ASt's L/gm, we cashed a Tue Night marquee going against them in their 55-40 loss (-3) to ULL and they do have another big SBC gm on deck vs S Bama. Will there be some look ahead?

LOUISIANA by 10 over South Alabama - The HT has won each of their 2 meetings by 22 pts. LTH UL -18' won 52-30 getting a td w/3:33 left for the cover. LY SA was -3 at home. UL was w/o their starting QB and also just accepted a bid to the New Orleans bowl and SA was at home trying for a 6th win for bowl eligibility. SA rolled them 30-8. With GA Southern not eligible for the post-ssn, the winner of this one takes a solid step towards not only a SBC champ, but also some bowl positioning. ULL is starting to look like the SBC fav's they were in the pre-season as they destroyed Texas St 34-10 (+2) and then LW had 419 yds rushing vs Ark St (7.5) with Elijah McGuire getting 265 yds on just 19 carries. ULL led 41-23 but it was 48-40 and they had to recover an onside kick (got a late TD to win 55-40, +3 cashing us a Tue Night Marquee). On the other side, SA had a 402-229 yard edge & led 27-6 when Troy went 80 yds (6 plays) for TD w/1:00 left to get a push L/Friday. We won't back off UL now as they've been there and done that and will be playing w/revenge.

VANDERBILT by 3 over Old Dominion - First meeting. This will be VU's 2nd non-conf matchup in their L/3 gms as they are in the middle of a Mizzou/UF sandwich. The young & inexperienced Commodores (31 frosh have pl'd) gave MO all they could handle LW as they were down just 3 w/under 3 min to play. Still, they were outg'd 385-240 incl 244-44 on the ground, while the FD's were nearly even. ODU is off a misleading 66-51 (+14) loss at WKU. Down 56-51 4Q & driving at the WKU 3-yd line, QB Heinicke had a WR wide open in the EZ, but the ball slipped out of his hand & was int'd & ret'd 94 yds for a td & obvious 14 pt swing. OD is 2-2 as an AD vs P5 conf tms while VU is 0-3 as a HF TY incl being outright upset by Temple & only beating UMass by 3 (-36 yds) and a FCS tm by 1 as a 20 pt fav (-94 yds). We'll take the dog here and give them an outside shot at the upset.

Rice by 4 over FIU - First meeting. Rice is still in contention in the CUSA West while FIU has been opportunistic in their conf slate. Rice is coming off a 41-21 (-14') come-from-behind win over NT. Down 21-14 at HT, the Owls scored all 27 2H pts & held 20-16 FD & 421-216 yd edges. FIU is fresh off a bye & a 45-13 (+21') home loss to Marshall the wk prior. The Golden Panthers are -50 ypg vs our #99 sked but are +10 in TO margin while Rice is +35 ypg vs our #82 sked. FIU is fresh off a bye. They were only outgained by Marshall 457-385, which was one of best games statistically vs the Herd and they are gaining confidence.

Homecoming & UCLA's only HG in a 5 wk span while pl'g a 6th str wk. This is a crucial tm in the wide open P12 South. AZ had won 5 in a row SU/4-1 ATS in this series until their LTH ('12) when they suff'd their worse loss in series history, 66-10 (+3'). LY pl'g w/revenge AZ trailed 24-10 late 3Q. Clinging to a 5 pt lead w/8:02 left UCLA forced a punt & int'd AZ in their L/2 poss. The HT is 7-3 SU/9-2 ATS. AZ is pl'g their 2nd str AG following a 59-37 win at WSU where QB Solomon tied his car high with 5 td passes. AZ was outFD'd 33-25 & outg'd 543-451, but were up 31-0 mid2Q before Wazzu got a lot of gbg late. UCLA is off a much tougher than expected 40-37 (-14) 2OT win over CU. Up 31-14 4Q, the Bruins all'd 17 unanswered incl the gm tying FG w/:36 left. Zona has cashed 3 str gms and knows how to win on road (see Oreg) while UCLA is 1-7 ATS and has failed to cover 4 str. Zona in another upset!

Washington by 3 over COLORADO - UW is on a 5-0 SU/ATS run in this series The last reg ssn win in this series for CU came in '90 during the Buff's 11-1-1 Nat'l Champ ssn. In their 3 P12 meetings, UW's been -16, -21 and -28 yet won by 28, 31 and 52 and have been +319 ypg! LY CU trailed 52-7 into the 4Q and UW never pulled scoring td's on 8 of 11 poss. UW is off a 24-10 (+3') home loss to ASU. They were tied at 10 in 4Q but ailed 2 td's in the L/3 min. HC Peterson hadn't lost B2B gms in a ssn s/'07. CU came back from a 17 pt 4Q deficit to force OT only to lose 40-37 (+14) to UCLA. CU had a 31-21 FD edge & the yds were nearly even. MacIntyre is 9-4 as a HD in career, 2-0 TY (both P12) and we'll back the pesky Buffs in this one.

OREGON ST by 4 over California - Homecoming. OSU has owned this series of late, winning 12 of the L/15 meetings SU. Cal is on an 0-3 SU/ATS run in this series incl a 62-14 (+14') blowout loss LTH ('12). Tied at 7 late 1Q, the Golden Bears all'd 42 unanswered being outgained 443-119 during that stretch. The HT is on a 3-1 ATS run & Cal hasn't won in Corvallis s/'06. LY we used OSU (-10') as the Inside Info Marquee Play. OSU rolled to an easy 49-17 win. OSU was manhandled in their 38-14 (+13') loss at SU LW as they were down 38-7 before scoring a gbg td w/3:54 left getting outFD'd 22-12 & outg'd 438-221. Cal is off a 59-41 (+21) loss to Oregon last Friday as we cashed a Fri Night Marquee on the OVER. Down just 10 at HT, the Golden Bears surrendered 2 3Q td's that blew the gm open in UO's favor. Cal is 3-0 as an AD TY incl 2 outright upsets (just 2-7 ATS as AD 2Y prior), but we'll call for the home tm w/the better D (#40-97) to get the win.

Colorado St by 4 over SAN JOSE ST - SJSSt has won 3 in a row SU/ATS in this series incl a pair of outright upsets. The Spartans have outgained CST by 182 and 161 yds the L2 meetings. LY tied at 27, CSU was int'd at the SJ28 and then a bubble screen turned into a 62 yd td w/5:36 left for SJSSt in the 34-27 (-3') win. CSU QB Grayson threw 5 td's to become the sch'l's all time leader w/53 in the Rams 45-31 (-18') win over WY. They were up 24-3 at HT & 45-17 4Q before WY got a couple of late td's. CSU has won 6 str gm for the 1st time s/'02. SJSSt is off a 41-31 (+8') loss at Navy. Th3 FD's & yds were fairly close but the Spartans trailed 38-17 mid 4Q. Surprising stat for us is CST's -16 ypg mark in MW while SJSSt is +235 ypg in MW play. That gives us a lot of value here.

ARIZONA ST by 3 over Utah - Homecoming. This gm will provide major implications in the P12 South race as both tms enter with just 1 loss apiece. ASU has won 10 in a row SU in this series by an avg of 24 ppg (Utah last win '76). LY they barely escaped 20-19 (-7). Utah led 19-7 after 3Q with ASU getting a td w/13:12 left. ASU went 81/6 for the GW td with 2:37 left. Utah was int'd on each of their final 2 drives. LW QB Kelly red'd after a month absence (foot) to lead ASU to a hard fought 24-10 (-3') win in Utah in a gm pl'd in heavy rain & wind. The Sun Devils were outFD'd 19-14 & outg'd 290-285 but did force 3 TO's incl returning an INT 61 yds for a td w/:52 left while UW was driving for the potential gm-tying score. The Utah QB job belongs to Wilson for now after leading the Utes to a hard fought win of their own, 24-21 (-1') over USC after tossing a 1-yd GW td pass w/:08 left. Utah OC Erickson cch'd ASU from '07-'11 w/32 ply'r's on ASU's roster signed by Erickson. ASU has a big game vs ND on deck and we'll call for this to go down to the wire as Utah is 2-0 as an AD TY w/2 outright upsets at the Big House and Rose Bowl.

Tcu by 7 over WEST VIRGINIA - ESPN's College Gameday will be on site in Morgantown for this matchup. These two have met twice recently and both times the visitor has pulled the upset. LTH ('12) TCU got a 94 yd td pass w/:28 left to force OT and won 39-38 (+3'). LY TCU (-12) had 454-415 yd & 30-25 FD edges. TCU had a PF pen in OT & missed a 62 yd fg & WV made a 34 ydr for the win. QB Boykin has firmly supplanted his spot on the Heisman watch list after re-setting his car high in pass yds for a 2nd str week while throwing a schl rec 7 td's in just 3Q's as we easily cashed a 2★ on these pages LW during the Horned Frogs 82-27 (-23) blowout win over TT. The 785 tl yds & 82 pts also set schl rec's. It was the most pts scored by a ranked tm over an FBS foe s/'10 (Wisc 83-20 over Ind). WV had no hangover after their upset win over BU 2 wks ago. Up 14-10 at HT the Mountaineers scored all 17 2H pts in their 34-10 (+3) win over OSU. TCU is 7-0 ATS TY while WV is on a 5-9 ATS run vs B12 foes.

Houston by 14 over USF - LY these two met for the first time s/'02. USF moved to 3-0 ATS in this series as they were +18 travelling on a Thurs night. The Cougars were about to put it away but fumbled into the EZ for a TB when they could have gone up 38-10. UCF down 28-23 had a td pass called back for off PI and fumbled on the next play. UH went 50/7 for a td to win 35-23. USF is off a 34-17 (+11) loss at UC last Friday as they were outFD'd 31-12 & outg'd 590-281 incl 273-42 on the ground while also committing 4 TO's (trailed 27-3). UH is fresh off a bye & a 31-10 (-7) Friday night win over Temple the week prior. They are on an 8-0 ATS run in AG's dating back to 2012. USF is playing a 4th str week, is off B2B AG's & is just 3-5 as a HD under HC Taggart.

FAU by 4 over Uab - Surprisingly despite UAB being favored in each of the L/4 gms, FAU is 4-1 SU/ATS w/3 str outright upsets. LY FAU was -3' & led 29-23 & drove 73/7 for a td w/1:22 left & won by 14 w/a 579-307 yd edge. LTH ('12) UAB (-5) led 28-24 after 3Q's but FAU got 2 td's to go up 38-28 before UAB got a td w/:33 left to lose 38-35. UAB is on their 4th AG in 5 wks incl a 3rd str & is coming off a physical 45-17 (+27) loss at Ark. They were outFD'd 24-12 & outg'd for the 1st time TY 484-195 as rFR QB Briscoe st'd in place of the inj'd Clements (CS) & went just 6-18-62-1-1. FAU couldn't hold onto a 16-14 HT lead at Marsh LW as they lost 35-16 (+28). The Owls did have 26-20 FD & 36:31-23:29 TOP edges but were outg'd 546-388. Against 2 common foes in FIU & WKU, both are 1-1 SU/ATS with UAB being +86 ypg while FAU is +127. With Clements status up in the air at presstime we'll call for the home tm by 4 and see if there's any value later in the wk.

UTEP by 7 over Southern Miss - SM is on a 3-1 ATS run in this series & the visitor is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in CUSA action. L/gm ('12) UTEP was -3' & led 34-27 4Q. SM went 86/7p getting a td w/2:48 but instead of an XP went for the win (2ptng; pass inc, SM came in 0-10). LTH ('11) the Golden Eagles won 31-13 (-10). UTEP is off a 34-0 (+10) shutout at UTSA. It was the Miners 1st shutout over an FBS foe s/'04 (NMSSt). The D forced 7 str 3&outs & all'd a UTEP modern era low 70 ttl yds!

SM is off a 31-20 (+9) loss vs LT. St'g QB Mullens was inj'd (foot) during the 1st series of the gm & backup QB Weeks went 28-45-338-1-2. After going just 1-4-1 as a HF the L2Y, UTEP is 2-0 in that role TY and we'll call for them to get surprising win #5 TY (only 5 wins combine in '12-'13).

New Mexico by 3 over UNLV - UNLV is on a 5-1 SU/ATS run in this series & the HT is on a 5-2 SU/ATS run. NM's last 2 trips here they've lost by an avg of 40-9. LTH ('12) LV led 21-0 at HT & went on to win 35-7 (-3') with a 530-350 yd edge. LY LV was -2' on the road & NM was fresh off a bye. The game was tied at 35 at HT (NM 441-308 yds) but LV would get the 56-42 win & HC Hauck was 0-21 SU on the road, but got his first road win and would win 3 LY LV is off a 34-20 (+17) loss at UST. They were outFD'd 18-13 & outg'd 444-282. NM is off a bye & a 35-31 (+7) loss at AF the week prior. NM is just 2-25 SU on the MW road but did pull the outright upset at UTSA 4 wks ago and we think they are the better team here.

Texas St by 4 over NEW MEXICO ST - The only prior gm was in San Marcos in '12. The Aggies lost 66-28 (+13') as both closed the book on the WAC. NMSSt led 21-14 into the 2Q but trailed 49-21 late 2Q due to def/ST td's. TXSt is off a 22-18 (+2) come-from-behind win at ULM that we cashed as our College Totals LPS GOM on the UNDER. Trailing 15-0 mid 3Q, the Bobcats rallied & after a crucial 4th Dn conv, RB Lowe scored the GW 21-yd td w/3:29 left. NMSSt is off a bye & a 29-17 (+5') loss at ID the week prior. NMSSt is 2-0-1 as a HD TY incl an outright upset win over Cal Poly in the ssn opener and we think LW's misleading gm and NMSSt's added rest gives us some value here, also NM St is -81 ypg in SBC play while Texas St is worse at -113 ypg.

OHIO ST by 35 over Illinois - This will be the 100th all-time meeting! The HT is now 7-3 ATS. In '07 IU (+15) upset #1 ranked OSU. Since then the Bucks are 6-0 SU/4-2 ATS winning by an avg of 36-16. LY OSU was needing pts in the BCS standings, was -34 on the road & jumped out to a 28-0 2Q lead, but Ill pulled within 44-29 & OSU got a td w/4:03 left to go up 53-35 and added another for the 25 pt win. OSU saw their 50+ pt scoring streak end at 4 str gms as QB Barrett was held to a pedestrian-like 74 pass yds (1-2 ratio) but they were still able to remain unbeaten in B10 play by winning 31-24 (-14) in 2OT at PSU & cashing a 3★ LPS on the OVER. After taking a 17-0 HT lead, the Bucks all'd 17 str pts (40-yd IR td being key) incl the tying fg w/:09 left to force OT. We cashed our underdog POW on these pages as Illinois scored the outright upset over UM 28-24 (+4). IU led 14-3 at HT but UM led 24-21 4Q before Bentley ret'd a fumble 12 yds for the GW td. OSU is on a 6-3 run as a B10 HF while IU is 2-9 as an AD under Beckman. Bucks get back on track here

FRESNO ST by 13 over Wyoming - FSU is 3-0 SU/ATS in their reg ssn meetings with WY winning a bowl in '09. The Cowboys are 0-4 SU in Fresno losing every gm by 11+ pts. LTH ('12) FSU was -16' and led 35-0 at HT, winning 42-14. LY FSU was -8 and temps dipped into the 40's (chilly for FSU). FSU failed to score in the 1Q for the first time all season and only led 14-10 at the half with a 246-214 yd edge but dominated the 2H finishing with a 600-296 yd edge and winning 48-10. WY is off a 45-31 (+18') loss at CSU in which they held the FD edge 25-24 & were only outg'd 558-454 but those stats are misleading as they were down 24-3 at HT & 31-3 late 3Q. FSU is fresh off a bye & a 37-27 (+17) loss at Boise the week prior. They are 10-5 as a HF under DeRuyter incl 2-0 TY, while WY is on a 4-8 ATS run in MW play.

NEVADA by 10 over San Diego St - SDSt is on a 3-0 SU/ATS run in this series. The last 2 meetings have gone to OT. LTH ('12) NV was -6' & led 31-21 w/7:46 left but the Aztecs got a td w/3:45 left and the game tying fg on the last play and in the 1st OT went for 2 and got it in the 39-38 win. LY the Aztecs appeared to have the game wrapped up as they were up 44-23 and dropped an int. NV rallied for three 4Q td's incl one with 1:38 left to force OT but in OT the Aztecs got a td and NV's 4&11 pass was incomplete. NV is off a 26-18 (-3) win at Hawaii. After spotting the Warriors a 10-0 lead, NV scored 26 unanswered before all'g a late garbage td w/:40 left. SDSt is fresh off a bye and a 20-10 (-7) win over UH the week prior. The Wolfpack have a bye on deck, can clinch bowl elig after a rare losing ssn LY and we'll call for them to do so here.

HAWAII by 3 over Utah St - UH was on a 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS run in this series but UST has won the L/2 meetings SU/ATS. LY UST was -24' at home and fresh off a bye. UH's flight was delayed due to a shooting at LAX and they did not arrive until 12 hrs before KO. The game was played in chilly weather and of course, altitude. UST led 23-3 at HT & would go onto win 47-10. LTH ('11) the Aggies won 35-31 (+3' & 1st win on the islands s/'66). UST trailed 28-7 at HT & 31-14 w/5:28 3Q. UST is off a 34-20 (-17) win over UNLV. QB Harrison was inj'd 3Q & replaced by true frosh Meyers (their 4th string QB they wanted to RS TY). UH is off a 26-18 (+3) loss vs NV. The Warriors held a 10-0 lead late 2Q, but all'd 26 unanswered until getting a late garbage td w/:40 left. Tough backing a true frosh here making his 1st start while Hawaii has been pesky all yr as despite their 2-6 record, they are getting outscored by just 4 ppg (-45 ypg) and we'll call for a break thru here.

Bowling Green at Akron - AU had been 4-1 SU in this series from '99-'06 but BG has now won 5 in a row SU/ATS winning by an avg of 34-19. LTH BG was -5 and won 24-10. AU dominated the 1H leading 10-0 but BG would outscore them 24-0 in the 2H. LY AU played a great 1H again (led 14-10). BG, however controlled the 2H and went 80/13 for a td w/4:19 left to get ahead of the spread, 31-14 (-15). Akron has the large D edge but BG has had 17 days to prep for this one. The winner will take the lead in the MAC East.

Toledo at KENT ST - KSU is 2-8 s/'88. In the L/gm ('10) KSU lost 34-21 (+3'). However, the Rockets are 3-10 in Kent incl a 40-14 loss (+7') the LTH ('06). UT is the only unbeaten tm left in MAC play but incredibly they have failed to cover 7 str gms TY. On the other side, Kent St is 1-7 SU/2-6 ATS but has been far more competitive in their L/4 gms. UT is clearly the better tm but will there be a look ahead to their nemesis N Ill who is on deck?

4★ SAN FRANCISCO over St Louis - SF is 8-4 ATS hosting the Rams with SF winning 3 in a row SU/ATS. They are just 2-7-1 ATS off the bye which the defense sorely needed & they should get LB Willis and possibly Aldon Smith (susp) back here along with LG Iupati. STL gave up 7 sacks to KC and are now 28th in sacks allowed (23 vs 36 LY) with the situation made worse by the loss of LT Long (ACL). The Rams were without their top 2 CB's LW and started a pair of rookies as STL gave up their 5th game with a defensive QBR of 100 or more (just 3 ints on the year). While Kaepernick has been inconsistent at times he does have a serviceable 94.3 QBR TY and the loss to DEN is forgivable as they were in a tough spot vs an elite team in primetime down multiple starters. They've outgained foes by 143 ypg at home TY (#3) and unlike the 1st matchup where they were caught by surprise early on in the game the 49ers will be read for what STL brings and are the play here.

FORECAST: SAN FRANCISCO by 18

3★ CLEVELAND over Tampa Bay - Not only have the Bucs been outgained by 115 ypg on the year (vs #32 sked!) they are the only team to not win the yardage battle in any game. They've gone 5 straight games under 100 yds rushing (69 ypg 3.5) and have been outscored 126-27 in the 1H which is on the coaching staff. If their best game of the year (PIT) is omitted they've allowed 130 ypg (4.3) rushing with just 5 sacks and their #31 pass defense is backed by a QBR of 104.3. While CLE did get outgained by OAK LW 80 yds was in garbage time being up 16 and happy to trade time for space. Hoyer rebounded off his dismal effort vs JAX (46.3 QBR) and has a 103.7 QBR at home. CLE's run game has stalled recently (39 yds 1.6 LW) and TE Cameron (concussion) is unknown here. However, CLE is in a favorable situation at home having proven they can cover as a td fav vs a team that didn't earn 100 yds offense until the 4th Qtr at home vs MIN and now has to travel.

FORECAST: CLEVELAND by 13

OTHER SELECTION

2★ Arizona (+) over DALLAS - This used to be the marquee matchup for ARZ in the old NFC East with desert bragging rights on the line. DAL is 2-6 ATS off MNF but one of the reasons for their success TY is that they've faced one top 10 offense (NO) and just 2 top 10 defenses (SF, SEA). They are +67 ypg at home TY (9th) prior to WAS and Murray's success TY (130 ypg 4.9) keeps Romo from having to make plays (103.6 QBR #8 at home) and making mistakes. ARZ is -94 ypg (#28) but 6-1 ATS on the road thanks to +5 TO's and some excellent coaching by Arians. The big matchup will be ARZ's #3 rush defense which hasn't allowed a 100 yd rusher TY and held PHI's McCoy to 83 yds. The Cardinals find themselves in an excellent situation getting points vs a team off a national TV game off an undermanned division rival and we'll take the AD here.

FORECAST: Arizona (+)

OTHER GAMES

New Orleans at Carolina - Thurs. Both teams off hosting elite NFC team but massive situational edge to Carolina with Saints off a Sunday Night'r and traveling. Not many times you can be 2-4 as the Saints were prior to last week and could potentially be playing this for the division lead. Technicals favor the Panthers at 2-1 as a div HD while the Saints are 1-6 ATS as a div AF but alot depends on how the Saints responded vs the Packers.

MIAMI by 4 over San Diego - SD lost to MIA 20-16 as a 1.5 pt AF LY despite a 435-343 yd edge as on 7 drives inside the MIA 36 they were held to 1 TD, 2 FG, an int, a punt and were SOD on the final play. SD is 0-3 SU/ATS after losing to DEN and the Broncos gave the NFL the plan for slowing down the Chargers defense by smothering the run (61 yds 4.1) and letting Rivers aggressive nature go against him (2 ints for 7 pts). SD has given up 136 ypg (4.6) the L3 games along with a 112.4 QBR with just 3 sacks in that span. MIA does take a huge step up after beating a youthful JAX team but the defense forced 3 TO's for 17 pts and the offense simply worked with favorable field position and let JAX get garbage yds late. The Dolphins are 2-1 ATS vs Brady, Rodgers and Cutler allowing 234 ypg (56%) with a 5-1 ratio (80.5 QBR) and are 5-2 ATS as a HF off a SU win and AD's off a Thursday game are 3-9 ATS. With extra rest and a bye on deck the Chargers can open it up here but MIA's defense has held up well the L3w so we'll call for them by 4 in a higher scoring game.

CINCINNATI by 15 over Jacksonville - The Jaguars lead the NFL in starts by rookies and it showed LW vs MIA as Bortles threw a pair of pick sixes and he's yet to have a game with a ypa over 7.5 (NFL avg). JAX is 3-6 ATS as a DD dog under Bradley and 3-8 ATS away vs NDIV foes. After being outgained by 66 ypg LY on the road (#29) they are up to -103 ypg (#29) now. JAX was outgained 270-158 in the 2H vs MIA and have been outscored 114-57 in the 2H TY. CIN is now 12-1 ATS at home with a 409-340 yd edge TY backed up by a formidable 56.8 defensive QBR outrushing foes by 50 ypg. JAX RB Denard Robinson has tallied B2B 100 yd games but he's 6-0 195 and CIN is allowing a respectable 98 ypg (4.9) rushing at home. The Bengals fully expect to have AJ Green on hand to get him ready for the CLE game and RB Bernard (hip) was taken out due to injury for the 3rd straight week. Look for CIN to build momentum vs a young team on the road but this isn't a key right now due to the backdoor potential with a short week on hand.

Washington by 1 over MINNESOTA - The Redskins are off LW's MNF event vs DAL with an outside chance of Griffin getting the start. WAS is on a 2-13 SU/4-11 ATS run prior to MNF being outscored 27-19. WAS has won the yardage battle in 6 of their L7 road games (354-296) but are -6 TO's and their QB inconsistency shows up in their 77.5 QBR. If the JAX game is

omitted WAS is allowing a 108.3 QBR and only has 6 sacks on the year. Keep in mind they are without #1 CB Hall, #1 OLB Orakpo and are travelling again after MNF with the only 2 games they've won the QBR battle TY being JAX/TEN. MIN is off their best game since ATL holding TB to 4 FD and 72 yds in the 1H but prior to that they hadn't earned 300 yds or a 60 QBR in 3 straight games. MIN is only 3-10 ATS as a favorite and off a win vs a disorganized foe and we'll take the points on the road with the possibility of Griffin being back.

HOUSTON by 5 over Philadelphia - The Texans do take a huge step up after facing a deflated TEN team that went with its 3rd QB of the year as the coach threw in the towel on 2014. Vs Eli (with Cruz), Romo, Luck and Roethlisberger the Texans have given up 297 ypg (67%) 10-2 ratio for a 108.3 QBR while Fitzpatrick has mustered an 82.1 QBR (4-5 ratio) in those games. Foster is rounding into his 2012 form though avg 130 ypg (6.3) which is a plus vs the #21 rush defense that had an easy matchup LW vs ARZ. PHI has faced 3 straight defenses ranked 21st or worse (avg'd 440-373) but this isn't the same PHI team as LY. PHI has been held to under a 90 QBR for 4 straight games and Foles has mediocre 6-7 ratio in that span with the defense having just 3 ints on the year. The public still expects big points and yards out of the Eagles (magnified by the shutout vs NYG) but fav's that earned 500 or more yds in a loss are just 1-7 ATS and we'll take the points here.

KANSAS CITY by 10 over NY Jets - The Jets became the 7th team in NFL history to have 2 QB's each log 3 or more TO's in a game and Rex hasn't decided who will start here. The Jets are 6-12 ATS away vs a NDIV foe and have given up 27 or more points in 8 of their L10 road games. Their 62.1 QBR on the road is 32nd while their 111.7 defensive QBR is 31st which is why they are -88 ypg (26th) on the road. KC is only allowing 191 ypg passing at home (65%) with a 5-3 ratio (91.8 QBR). Minus SF and TEN the Chiefs are outrushing foes 162 (4.4) to 91 (5.1) with Smith having a 100.3 QBR or better in 4 of 5 games. The Chiefs don't have the receiving weapons to blow out foes but they are very efficient moving the ball with 3 drives of 70+ yds vs a similarly talented Rams defense LW. KC is a bad HF (3-12 ATS) but with the Jets deplorable QB situation we'll call for the home team by 10 here.

Denver by 6 over NEW ENGLAND - This is the 16th meeting between Brady and Manning inc playoffs with Brady owning a 10-5 SU and Manning being 6-11 SU vs Belichick. This is the start of a 3 game road trip for DEN but just their 3rd road game of the season. Since their loss to SEA (the only game w/a QBR below 110) the Broncos have outgained foes by 184 ypg (+3 TO's) winning by 18 ppg. The difference between LY and 2014 is the defense as they have allowed just 1 game with a QBR over 100 and they've held foes to 48 ypg rush (2.9) L4W. NE throttled an injury depleted CHI defense (no LB Briggs, depleted secondary) but the #12 defense hasn't faced a top 10 offense all year (just one top 10 team in our position talent in KC) getting fattened up the L3w on a dysfunctional CHI, woeful NYJ and the Bills who they own. Home teams are 5-17 ATS off B2B home wins and while Brady isn't done by a longshot their defensive injuries catch up to them here.

SEATTLE by 16 over Oakland - The line reflects how poor the situation is for OAK who are off a road game to CLE and now have to go up to SEA. OAK is the oldest team in the NFL and being led by a promising rookie QB going to one of the most hostile venues in the NFL. SEA had 4 drives inside the CAR 25 LW but settled for 1 TD, 1 FG and 2 TO's. They held CAR to 5 FD and 113 yds in the 2H but find themselves chasing ARZ in the NFC West. SEA only gave up 2 games w/a QBR over 100 at LY (at IND, vs TB) but have done so 4 times TY and have just 3 ints vs 28 LY. Carr only has 1 game (SD) over the NFL avg of 7.5 ypa TY and have given up a 111.4 QBR to the set of Tannehill, Rivers, Palmer and Hoyer. SEA has struggled with the fact that they are the #1 target in the NFL clearly but the fact Raiders have been outscored 81-40 in the 1st & 3rd Qtrs points to coaching and even more glaring is that they only have one player with 400 yds offense thru 7 games.

Baltimore at Pittsburgh - Sun Night - We're not one's to call the NFL schedule makers completely idiotic but the Ravens are playing their NINTH game of the season and this is their 5th of 6 divisions games! Not only are the Ravens also playing B2B division road games but they are traveling for the 4th time in 5 weeks. What has been amazing in this series is that the last SEVEN times BAL has visited Heinz Field the game has been decided by exactly 3 points.

Indianapolis at NY Giants - Monday - Both teams are off tough losses with the Colts expending a ton of energy vs the Steelers giving up the 4th most passing yards in NFL history without their top CB. IND is 14-1 ATS off a loss and favored but the Giants have won 6 straight outright off a bye and with their injuries and the Colts being a popular public team the line may go higher. A win over a quality foe would jump start the 2nd half of the season for the Giants but can they hold off Luck's competitive fire?
