4★ Texas St over GEORGIA ST - LY was their first meeting. It was GST's 1st SBC road gm & TSt won 24-17 (-16') giving them their 1st ever SBC win. The Panthers were shutout for the 2nd time in their L/3 gms LW by Clemson 28-0 (+40') but QB Arubuckle did set the school's single ssn passing rec with 2,941 yds. The Bobcats enter off a 45-27 (+6) win over Ark St last Thursday night as they never trailed to become bowl elig. RB Lowe ran for a car high 236 yds & 4 td's. TXSt is on a 5-0 ATS run overall, have covered their L/2 as an AF and have covered all 5 of their AG's TY. GST is on a 1-3 run as a HD and is just playing out the ssn here w/limited scholarships while TSt can better position itself for its 1st ever bowl. Also notable is a GST D all g 300 rush ypg (6.1) TY while TSt is avg 230 rush ypg (5.1) in SBC play TY. Bobcats roll!

FORECAST: Texas St by 20

3★ UCLA over Stanford - Friday. Stanford has now won 6 in a row SU in this series (5-1 ATS). This is an unusual situational spot for these two as Stanford is off rival Cal while UCLA just ply'd USC and the 2 tms meet on a short wk. LTH Stanford rolled over the Bruins 35-17 (-3) leading 35-10 before giving up a td w/1:53 left. LY SU had a 192-74 yd rush edge (much more exp'd OL) and 419-266 overall yd edge and won 24-10 (-4'). LW the Cardinal won the Big Game for a 5th str yr as they benefitted from 5 Cal TO's (just a 418-410 yd edge) in their 38-17 win (-5). On the other side, the Bruins dominated cross-town rival USC for a 3rd str yr as they had a 461-276 yd edge in their 38-20 win (-4). It would have been worse but USC got a 17 yd IR td and also drove 91 yds late in the gm for a td. The Bruins are clearly playing their best ball of the ssn w/5 str wins and 3 str covers. Stanford's huge win over Cal gave us some value here and we'll call for the Bruins to break their series losing streak and head north to Santa Clara for next week's Pac-12 Title gm vs Oregon.

FORECAST: UCLA by 10

3★ Northern Illinois over WESTERN MICHIGAN - Friday. WM won 3 in a row from '06-'08 but NI has dominated since going 5-0 SU with their avg win 40-19. The HT is 10-5 ATS. WM HC Fleck was a star WR and then was the OC at NIU. LY we won a Tue Night Marquee on WM +35 in a 33-14 gm played in frigid conditions. The MAC West Title is on the line here as a NIU win here puts them in their 5th str MAC Title gm, while WM needs a win and a UT loss to get to Detroit. The Broncos could be the MIP tm in the country TY and no doubt have been the most profitable as LW they moved to 8-3 (just 1-11 LY) and covered their 10th str gm by claiming the Michigan MAC champ in their 32-20 (+1) win at rival CMU. While this is uncharted territory for the Broncos, NIU is used to playing these types of gms. While we certainly respect WMU's ATS win streak here, that streak gives us an incredible 42 pt line swing in this game from LY. NIU has been here and done that and haven't been a TD conf dog s/11.

FORECAST: N Illinois by 1

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ South Carolina over CLEMSON - This will be the 112th all-time meeting. In all of Clemson's meeting rooms a clock counts down the time to their ssn ending meeting w/SC. The clocks also reads "0-5", which is their record against SC in the past 5 gms. CU was 10-2 SU/8-4 in this series from '97-'08 but SC has now won 5 in a row SU/ATS. LY CU came in #6 and SC #10. CU had a 352-318 yd edge & the gm was tied 17-17 after 3Q's but CU had four 4Q TO's & lost 31-17 (+3'). Both are essentially off byes as the Tigers beat GST 28-0 (-41) & the Gamecocks beat USA 37-12. Against their 1 common foe (UGA) CU lost by 24 (-168 yds) while SC won by 3 (+39 yds). SC has the offensive edge esp w/Clem QB Watson most likely out for this (Clem has failed to cover 6 str gms w/Stout at QB). Normally we like taking defensive home teams as Clem has a huge D edge (#3-80), but until Swinney gets the best of Spurrier, we'll back the Ol Ball coach here again.

FORECAST: South Carolina by 1

2★ NEW MEXICO over Wyoming - NM was 9-2 SU in this series from 2000-'10. WY has won the L/3 in a row, but NM is on a 10-5 ATS run. While the HT is 5-1 SU, the visitor is 8-3 ATS. LY WY was up by 14 but NM went 72/12 & got a 23 yd td pass w/1:06 left for the backdoor cover. This will be the final gm of the ssn for both schools as neither are bowl elig. The Lobos are off a 58-20 (+21) loss at CSU while the Pokes lost 63-14 (-14) to BSU (most pts all'd at home s/1922). NM is on a 1-3 SU/6-2 ATS run in home finales. Keep in mind, WY held AF's option to just 151 (2.9) rush yds earlier TY but this unit has been depleted injury wise and now on the other side, QB Kirkegaard is exp to miss here. Also prior to LW, NM had been playing solid (4 str covers) FB and we'll call for the HT by a td here who is also 5-1 ATS as a HF.

OTHER GAMES

Thursday, November 27th

Tcu by 6 over TEXAS - The power shift in the state of Texas has been made as TCU is playing with playoff implications and a Big 12 title while UT barely became bowl eligible (however, look out for the Horns next yr). Both schools enter fresh off byes. LY the Longhorns (+2') were a 4★ LPS and dominated the game w/a 415-246 yd edge but there was a 3hr 6min rain delay & the gm didn't finish until the wee hours of the morning. UT led 27-7 in the 3Q and added a 36 yd fg w/11:55 left to close the scoring. The Frogs survived a scare at KU in their L/gm as they were down by 10 late 3Q, but won 34-30 (-28) cashing us a 3★ College Totals LPS on the OVER. UT dominated OSU 28-7 (-2') holding the Pokes to just 9 FD & 192 ttl yds in becoming bowl eligible as we cashed a 3★ College LPS on the Horns. They have now won and covered 3 str (avg cover of 18 ppg) and with TCU playing w/playoff pressure (0-5 ATS as B12 AF), we'll back the defensive (#5) home dog.

Lsu by 4 over TEXAS A&M - LSU is now a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS in their L/3 meetings winning by an avg of 15 ppg despite just being an avg of -3'. LY in Death Valley Manziel had one of his worst games in his career hitting just 16-41 w/a couple of int's & LSU led comfortably throughout in their 34-10 win (-5). Both come in off a bye and this is the Aggies' FHG (6-3-1 ATS). A&M has a history of playing on Thanksgiving as from 1985-2011 they played Texas 11 times in front of ESPN cameras and were 8-3 SU. The Tigers lost the Battle of the Boot 17-0 (-1) to Ark in their last gm as they were shutout for the 1st time s/the 2012 Nat'l Champ gm (we cashed a Weekly Totals play on the UNDER). On the other side, the Aggies all'd a struggling Missouri offense to gain a ssn high 587 yds & lost 34-27 (-3'). Both tms have been Jekyll & Hyde due to their youth (esp at skill pos), but LSU gets the nod here because they have the much better D (#4-68) and their rush offense should have a field day w/A&M's D all g 255 rush ypg (5.8) in SEC play TY.

Friday, November 28th

VIRGINIA TECH by 1 over Virginia - Commonwealth Cup (VT has had it for 3,650 str days). This has not been much of a rivalry game as VT is 14-1 SU (10-5 ATS) incl 10 wins in a row. LY VT won 16-6 (-12). Both tms are 5-6 and need a win for bowl elig. In UVA HC London's case, a win here would no doubt save his job. Despite the similar records, VT has clearly underachieved TY (4-7 ATS) as inj's have decimated them while UVA has overachieved (8-3 ATS) and LW we cashed a 3★ on these pages in their dominating 30-13 upset win (+5) over Miami. On the other side, VT was abysmal in their 6-3 2OT loss (-15) to WF as it was the 1st FBS gm s/05 to end regulation with no score. It was also their 1st loss to WF s/'83. The Hokies are now 2-7 ATS and Beamer's program has no doubt grown stale. Virginia has the better offense, better D but it's tough to ignore the series domination here.

BOWLING GREEN by 6 over Ball St - BG has won 6 str incl a 31-17 win (-3) in the L/gm ('09). This gm comes down to motivation. The Falcons are off their huge rivalry gm against UT where they lost for the 5th str time (27-20, +6') and they have the MAC Title gm on deck (could have a rematch vs N Ill who they beat LY or face UT again). On the other side, Ball St will be sitting at home TY as they are 4-7 following a 45-30 win (-17) over EM LW. BG is -58 ypg on the ssn and while it is their FHG, we'll fade them here as they are 0-3 ATS as a HF TY vs FBS foes while Lembo sports a solid 11-5 ATS mark as an AD.

Buffalo by 1 over MASSACHUSETTS - LY BU was -19' at home and led 13-3 at HT before going onto win 32-3. The Bulls home finale was cancelled LW after a severe snow storm swept the area. In their previous gm, they had their best performance of the ssn in a 55-24 win (+3') over Akron. On the other side, UMass had their 6 gm ATS win streak snapped in their 30-6 (+7) loss at Akron last Tuesday (cashed a Marquee on the UNDER) as they were held to just 11 FD's & 235 ttl yds while turning the ball over 4X. A lot of that can be attributed to the fact QB Frohnapfel (ankle) didn't play (b/kp Whipple just 12-20-157-1-3). As of press time, the MAC's leading passer is double and no one in the MAC could be more valuable to his tm than him.

MARSHALL by 20 over Western Kentucky - This will mark just the 2nd meeting s/52. WKU lost 37-3 in '96 (LTH). The 11-0 Thundering Herd got their biggest scare of the ssn LW in their 23-18 win (-20) over UAB. They did have a 515-346 yd edge but scored a defensive TD and stopped the Blazers deep inside Herd territory in the final minute. Prior to that gm, their closest gm came in the opener, which was a 15 pt win. On the other side, WKU has won 3 str gms and is bowl elig after their 45-7 win (-10) over UTA LA. Despite being +230 ypg in their L/2 gms, the Hilltoppers are still -22 ypg in CUSA play TY, while Marshall is +221 ypg. Despite playing w/undefeated pressure, this is the FHG for QB Cato and the Herd are 9-1-1 ATS as a HF (WKU 1-4 as AD). We look for a comfortable Herd win but WKU does have backdoor potential.

Toledo by 20 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - UT is 13-0 SU in this series and 9-2-1 ATS but the HT is 8-2-1 ATS. In their L/6 HG in this series, UT is +250 ypg, however, their last 5 on the road vs the Eagles, they are just +43 ypg. LTH UT won 52-47 (-14') w/only a 655-624 yd edge. LY UT had a 456-182 yd edge at half and led 35-10. They would cruise 55-16 (-30'). The Rockets need a win and a NIU loss to get to the MAC Title gm. They are off their 5th str win over rival BG and outside of QB inj's have been the most impressive tm in the MAC TY. On the other side, EM is 2-8 and LW trailed Ball St 35-3 early 3Q before scoring 27 pts and getting a majority of their 30 FD's and 503 yds afterwards (lost 45-30, +17). UT loves to run the ball as they are avg 254 rush ypg (5.9) and will be taking on a EMU rush D that allows 229 rush ypg (5.4). However, could the Rockets get caught scoreboard watching in the 2H (NIU/MM kicks off 2 hrs earlier)?

IOWA by 3 over Nebraska - NU used to play CU after Thanksgiving but their opp has now been Iowa the L/3 and they are 2-1 SU but 1-2 ATS with the visitor winning 2 in a row. LTH NU (-16) trailed 7-3 at the half but held IU to 70 2H yds and won 13-7. LY the Huskers were -2' at home and did have a 20-14 FD edge. IU only had 281 yds but st'd 7 drives from inside NU terr (25, 41, 24, 39, 27 incl) that keyed a much closer than 38-17 final. We've thought the Huskers have been overrated all yr and the L/2 wks have shown their true colors in a blowout loss to Wisc and LW we cashed another outright upset for our Big Dogs as Minny beat them 28-24 (+10') in Lincoln. HC Pelini is now just 1 more loss away from doing what he always does; lose 4 gms in a ssn (would be 7th str yr). On the other side, Iowa is 7-4 and played a solid gm LW before succumbing to Wisc 26-24 (+10). Neb has failed to cover 4 str gms, has no shot at the Big 10 champ and is -4 ypg in B10 play TY, while Iowa is 6-1 ATS off a SU loss the L/2Y and is +102 ypg in B10 play TY.

East Carolina by 14 over TULSA - These two were among the top teams in CUSA each year and joined the AAC TY. Surprisingly EC is a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS in this series. They pulled outright upsets 3 str yrs in '08, '09 and '10 and LY EC was -16' at home and got a 100 yd IR td late to win by 34. After 5 str ATS losses, the Pirates beat Tulane 34-6 LW (-19) but they do have a huge gm vs UCF on deck. On the other side, while it's been a disappointing ssn for the Hurricane, they haven't given up as LW, they were tied at 28 late 4Q before falling 38-28 (+20) at Houston. They are only -35 ypg in AAC play but ECar sports a +160 ypg mark. EC is 0-3 ATS as an AF TY and have been upset twice and while we won't call for the outright upset here, Tulsa's offense which avg's 469 ypg and nearly 30 ppg at home is capable of pulling the backdoor.

Houston by 20 over SMU - UH is 8-2 SU/5-5 ATS series. LTH SMU pulled the upset 72-42 (+5) as they were incredibly +79 in TO's (outgained 560-384). UH was poised for revenge -9' LY and got their first conf shutout s/'89, 34-0. The HT is 5-1 ATS. After 2 str covers, the Ponies were right back at being arguably the worst tm in the country as LW they fell to UCF 53-7 (+28). They are now -266 ypg on the ssn and have been outscored by 34 ppg and sit as the only winless tm in the country. On the other side, UH got to bowl elig w/a 38-28 win (-20) over Tulsa LW but the gm was tied at 28 mid-4Q and quite honestly they have been a bit underwhelming TY especially at home in their new stadium (2-5 ATS). Now they hit the road where they are 3-0 ATS TY but 2 of those were in underdog roles and this number is a bit steep for our liking especially w/a UH offense that hasn't met expectations TY.

Navy by 10 over SOUTH ALABAMA - Joey Jones is not fond of facing the option. Two years ago they took on CP's option and lost 41-10, their worst defeat in school history. LY they took on the option again and Navy drilled them 42-14 (+7') and TY they lost at home to Ga Southern 28-6 (+3). After getting to bowl elig for the 2nd str yr, SA fell to S Car LW 37-12 (+24). Hunter Vaughn in his 1st road start threw 4 picks and the gm featured a combined 10 TO's. Navy is fresh off a bye with a bye on deck. They had arguably their best performance of the ssn in their L/outing, a 52-19 (-3) win over Ga Southern and need 1 more win to clinch a bid to the Poinsettia Bowl. SA is playing a 7th str week and is just 1-5 ATS all-time as an AD. We'll take the Mids by DD's here.

MISSOURI by 1 over Arkansas - The last & only time these two played here was in 1906 and this is the first reg ssn meeting s/'63. The L/gm was the '07 Cotton Bowl, a 38-7 win (-3) for the Tigers. Both tms are off huge SEC wins as Ark after snapping their 17-gm SEC losing streak 2 wks ago, got their 2nd str shutout as they beat Ole Miss 30-0 (+3) giving us a 3★ Totals LPS winner on the UNDER. The Hogs did benefit from 6 Ole Miss TO's incl a 100-yd IR td. On the other side, you gotta give credit to Gary Pinkel and Co. After a shocking SEC East Title LY, they can make it B2B East Titles here w/a win as LW they notched a schl-rec 10th str road win in their 29-21 victory (+4) over Tenn. After struggling for much of the ssn, their offense has come alive the L/2 wks. While we feel Ark maybe the better tm, they are off 2 big wins, have clinched bowl elig, had a very misleading gm LW (also QB Allen is ? here) while Mizzou just knows how to win despite not being that impressive statistically (+19 ypg in SEC play despite a 6-1 record).

ARIZONA by 3 over Arizona St - The HT has won the Territorial Cup just once in the L/5Y. LY UA trailed 27-0 mid-2Q & never got closer than 16 in the 2H in a 58-21 loss (+11) that was closer than the final (only outgained 478-424). The Wildcats are off their most impressive win of the ssn, a 42-10 (+4) whitewashing of Utah on the road. However, QB Solomon was fitted for a walking boot at HT because of an apparent injury to his right foot. He will be evaluated early this wk. ASU continues to win w/smoke and mirrors as LW despite a 21 pt win over Wash St, they were outgained by 292 yds and benefitted from +5 TO's. They are now getting outgained by 23 ypg in Pac-12 play (Arizona just +1 ypg in conf) and its a big play waiting to happen on nearly every play on the defensive side for them as they either get a sack, force a TO or give up a big play w/their blitzing schemes. If UCLA loses to Stanford (played at same time), then the winner here gets the Pac-12 South Title and despite the fact it's been a visitor series, we'll take the HT by a FG and watch the injury report on Solomon and also ASU WR Strong.

Colorado St by 3 over AIR FORCE - This is a great CSt schedule situation. They just had a bye two weeks ago to prep for NM's option and now get the option in B2B weeks. The favorite is 9-3 ATS in this series. AF had won 6 in a row SU vs Col St with their wins by 25, 24, 18, 22, 24 and 21 pts. LY we had a 3★ Key Selection on these pages on CSU and they delivered an easy winner. The 58-13 final was AF's worst loss ever to CSU and the series dates back to 1957. TY the Rams come in on a 9-gm win streak as LW they crushed NM 58-20 (-21) as they amassed a program-best 698 yds of offense and Bama trans RB Hart had a schl-rec 6 td's. Despite their gaudy 10-1 record, they could miss out on not only a major bowl bid but also the MW Title gm if Boise beats Utah St. On the other side, the 8-3 Falcons are off a 30-14 loss (+6) to San Diego St as it was arguably their worst performance of the ssn. The Rams are playing w/some pressure here and we think LW's results inflated this line a little.

UCF by 11 over USF - UCF lobbied hard for this matchup (just 98 miles apart) but USF often refused to play them. USF from '05-'08 was 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in this series. LY UCF was -26' at home but were fortunate to win as they got a 52 yd td pass with 4:30 left for the 23-20 victory. After an 0-2 start, UCF has won 7 of 8 and is off a dominating 53-7 win (-28) over SMU LW as they had 27-4 FD and 490-116 yd edges. USF, meanwhile has been eliminated from bowl contention after LW's 31-20 loss (+20) to Memphis. Much to the dismay of us, they scored a 9-yd TD on 4th Dn w/1:14 left that had the gm go OVER the total. While UCF is a dominating +153 ypg in AAC play (USF -61), the Knights home/away dichotomy (home +191 ypg, away -72) may have us backing off a large number here as USF played them tough LY and UCF has a huge gm vs ECU on deck.

Akron by 3 over KENT ST - These two play for the Wagon Wheel Trophy and are just 12 miles apart. LY was actually 8-5 ATS from '97-'09. Kent won 3 in a row SU the next 3 yrs but UA reclaimed the Trophy LY. UA led 13-7 and KST was int'd at the UA4. UA went 60/12 for a 29 yd fg w/4:25 left, 16-7 (-1' HF) and that was the final. Both tms have had disappointing yrs as Kent comes in winless in MAC play after LW's UB gm was cancelled due to the extreme weather. Akron after a 4-2 start has dropped 4 of 5 and are on a 1-5 ATS run but did get off the mat LW in their 30-6 win (-7) over UMass that gave us a Tue Night Marquee winner on the UNDER. They are clearly the better tm and are going for bowl elig here for the 1st time s/'05. However, we'll fade them a bit here as they are 2-11-1 ATS as an AF incl 0-3 TY getting outright upset each time.

Saturday, November 29th

OHIO ST by 17 over Michigan - OSU is 9-1 SU in this series and 7-3 ATS in perhaps the greatest rivalry in CFB. In the last 9Y OSU has been ranked in the top 10 eight times and won all 8 SU when their only loss in '11 when UM was #17 and OSU was unranked. Nobody gave UM a chance LY as #3 OSU was -16 on the road. For the first time in 71 years the Bucks had a game after UM as they had the Big10 Title game on deck. UM got a td w/3:2 left but went for 2 and it failed in the 42-41 loss. The Bucks again have the B10 Title gm on deck as LW they clinched the East division by winning their 23rd str B10 reg ssn gm. However, it wasn't that impressive as they trailed hapless Indiana 20-14 in the 3Q before scoring 4 td's in the final 17:20. They will need to make a statement here to build their playoff resume. Speaking of resumes, Brady Hoke will be needing to dust off his as LW's 23-16 loss (-5) to MD pretty much sealed his fate. While the Buckeyes should cruise here, this is a rivalry gm and each of the L/3 have gone down to the wire. Also Mich's D is still holding its opp's to 103 ypg less than their ssn avg (#9) and are giving up just 21 ppg.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 9 over Syracuse - These 2 were rivals in the BE and ply'd every year up to '04. LY BC was -2' at Syr and suffered a very tough loss. Up 1 w/just minutes left, BC had a 1&g at the 5 and the game well in hand but on 3&T threw a pass that went OOB and they got a 21 yd fg failing to knock :40 off the clock. SU would drive 75/8 and because of the extra time, scored a 8 yd td with :06 left to pull out the win. TY BC is heading to a bowl while the Cuse will be staying home. The Eagles almost pulled off another outright upset winner for our Big Dogs as they fell to the defending champs 20-17 (+17) on the final play. On the other side, a depleted Cuse tm is just playing out the ssn at this pt as they were mauled 30-7 (+7') at Pitt getting outFD'd 28-12 and outgained 445-255. They are still only -5 ypg on the ssn despite their 3-8 record. BC is 6-2 ATS as a HF but is getting outgained by 27 ypg in conf play and it's tough laying too many pts here w/an offense that avg's just 22 ppg in conf play and there have been 4 consec outright upsets in this series.

FAU by 3 over Old Dominion - 1st meeting. We went against both of these tms LW and both of them beat us. FAU was 3-7 and beat-up (giving up 224 rush ypg, 5.5 ypc) and playing a physical MT tm (avg 210 rush ypg, 4.7) that was going for bowl elig, playing at home in cool conditions. While MT got the 35-34 win, FAU got the cover (+7) for a disappointing 4.5★ College LPS loss. On the other side, LT came in on a 8-2 ATS run and had been winning their conf gms by 26 ppg. They were taking on an ODU tm that had failed to cover in 6 str gms. Final score: ODU 30 LT 27 in OT. ODU is going for a respectable 6-6 record here in their 1st yr of FBS play while FAU took a step back in HC Partridge's 1st yr. Two similar tms and we'll call for the HT by a FG.

Duke by 17 over Wake Forest - WF had won an amazing 12 in a row SU in this series but was only 5-7 ATS. Duke has now won the last 2Y. The visitor is 10-6-1 ATS and the L7G have been decided by 5 ppg. LY Duke came in ranked for the first time s/'95 and WF was +7 at home. Duke was off a huge win over Miami and was an AF in the ACC for the first time s/'99. We had an underdog POW on WF on these pages and it pushed. The underdog is 10-5-1 ATS but WF has been favored 15 of 16 games and this will be the 1st time Duke has been a TD+ fav in the series s/'95. The Blue Devils after a "fool's gold" 8-1 start, have come back to earth in the L/2 wks suffering B2B losses. LW we used NC as our NC Sports Complimentary Underdog POW (given out FREE on button #3 every Tue at 1-347-677-1700) and the Tar Heels easily upset the Blue Devils 45-20 improving our Underdog comp record to 18-6 75% w/17 outright upsets the L/2 yrs. Speaking of upsets, LW in a gm that set offensive FB back a 100 yrs, WF pulled out a 6-3 (+14') 2OT win over VT as it was the 1st gm in 9 yrs to end scoreless in regulation. While WF is a terrible -219 ypg in ACC play, Duke is -101 ypg. We also wonder what frame of mind the Blue Devils will be in here after blowing their chance at getting to the ACC Champ gm for a 2nd str yr.

Tennessee by 17 over VANDERBILT - This is VU's home finale. UT had dominated this series going 28-1 vs VU dating back to '82. After UT had beaten VU in '11, in the locker room then UT HC Dooley made a comment saying they always kick VU's ass and then Vandy HC Franklin used that as a motivating tool the next year in Vandy's 41-18 (-3) win. LY UT needed a win to keep alive its bowl hopes and probably should have won the game. They led 10-7 and stopped VU on 4&1 but they reviewed the spot and gave VU a FD and then got a td w/16 left to pull out a 14-10 win (+2). TY there will be no upset as the Doers are nowhere near as good as they've been the L/3 yrs (-25 ppg, -194 ypg in SEC play) while the Vols are much improved. LW they did fall to Mizzou 29-21 (-4) due to several inj/susp, had to start 7 true frosh for the 1st time in schl history. They can still get to their 1st bowl s/'10 w/a win here. The Vols are 9-3 ATS as an AF, are +4 ypg TY despite playing our #3 sked, while Vandy is 2-5 ATS at home TY.

WISCONSIN by 16 over Minnesota - The Battle for Paul Bunyan's Axe will also be the battle for the Big Ten's West Division Champ as the winner here meets OSU in Indy next week. UW has won a series high 10 str incl a 20-7 win (-16') LY. They are on a 8-4 ATS run in the series. In LY's gm UW settled for 20 and 31 yd FG's and gave up a 39 yd IR td. Both tms won critical conf road gms LW as Minny got us another outright upset winner for our Big Dogs in their 28-24 (+10) win over Nebraska. You gotta give it to HC Kill and his roster of 3★ players as they are a scrappy bunch that brings their lunch pail each week. However, now they are facing one of the biggest bulls in the country as the Badgers are off a 26-24 win (-10) over Iowa and have won 6 str. At home TY, they are a ridiculous +333 ypg incl an avg of 400-89 in rush ypg. This will be the FHG for Gordon who looks to build on his Heisman candidacy and while we respect Kill (8-1 ATS run as dog w/4 outright upsets), look for the Badgers to wear them down and their D could benefit w/Minny RB Cobb ?.

MIAMI, FL by 13 over Pittsburgh - These two used to be BE rivals and were back together in the ACC LY. UM is now 8-0 SU/6-2 ATS in this series. LY it was 33' at game time and normally UM folds in cold weather but UM led 31-10 at half with a 317-213 yd edge and went on to a 41-31 win (-3). LW on these pages, we cashed a 3★ Key Selection against the Canes as they were in a terrible situation off FSU, (UVA off a bye) and they lost 30-13 (-5). On the other side, Pitt needing wins in their final 2 gms to get to their 7th str bowl crushed Syracuse 30-7 (-7') w/a 445-255 yd edge. Despite not having much of a HF adv, the Canes are much better at home (+19 ppg, +189 ypg) than away (-6 ppg, +10 ypg) a sign of a young team. After B2B losses, we look for the Canes to get back on track as they have the D

(UM all'g just 65 rush ypg, 2.1 at home) to stop Pitt RB Conner who missed LW's 2H w/an inj (CS).

MARYLAND by 7 over Rutgers - In the L/gm ('09) UM lost 34-13 (+1). UM led 13-10 at HT but were shutout in the 2H and outgained 173-63 (-3 TO's). Obviously the big story here is the return of OC Friedgen to the place where he played OG, was a GA, OC and then HC from 2001-2010 and was unceremoniously fired in a year where he won the ACC COY award (went 9-4). Both tms have locked up bowl bids and this gm is for positioning. MD is off a big 23-16 (+6) win over Michigan LW (were outgained by 86 yds) as they scored 2 td's in the 4Q. We did cash a 3★ College Totals LPS on the UNDER. It was the same ol story vs the Big Ten's elite as LW Rutgers was overwhelmed by Mich St in a 45-3 loss (+22'). They are -123 ypg in B10 play and have all'd 290 rush ypg (6.5) in their L/5 wks. While we think MD is the better tm, they are -111 ypg in B10 play, are avg just 90 rush ypg (2.9) in B10 play and may not be able to wear down RU like the Ohio St's, Wisc and Mich St's did.

LOUISIANA TECH by 7 over Rice - A winner take all battle for the CUSA West Division. The HT is 4-2 SU and 2-4 ATS. There have been 3 outright upsets the L5Y and while Rice is 3-3 SU in this series, they are 5-1 ATS. LY Rice was playing with emotion for HC Bailiff as his father died during the week and at the half Rice had a 295-126 yd edge and led 24-0 and would cruise 52-14 (-14'). LW LT off a bye had a chance to lock up the CUSA West division but after pummeling most of their CUSA foes, they were upset at ODU 30-27 (-11') in OT. On the other side, Rice rebounded off a loss to Marshall and beat a MIP UTEP tm 31-13 (-7) as we unfortunately had a 4★ Key Selection on these pages against them. While we don't want to overreact to LW's results, Rice is on a 7-3 ATS run as an AD, have covered 7 of their L/8 gms overall and it's always tough getting a feel for a Skip Holtz tm (lost outright to FCS NWSU TY) especially as a favorite.

NORTH CAROLINA by 7 over NC State - This will be the 104th meeting as this gm has been pl'd every year s/'53. Prior to NC's current 2 game win streak, NCSt had won 5 str incl 4 str as a dog. Fedora puts a lot into this game and decorates the NC locker room in red with NCSt's slogan "Our State" to emphasize it. LTH NC led 25-7 but NCSt battled back to lead 35-25. NC got a Giovanni Bernard 74 yd PR td on the last play then bobbled the snap on the xp and took it in for 2 and the miracle cover -7 (43-35). LY NC won 27-19 (-5'). After the win several NC players ran to midfield and celebrated on the NCSt logo which NCSt players thought was disrespectful and HC Doeren said "they'd remember that for the next 364 days." The Wolfpack are bowl elig for the 4th time in 5Y & enter fresh off a bye & in their last gm defeated WF 42-13 (-16') as they ran for 362 yds, its most s/90 while snapping a 7 gm home ACC losing streak. LW we easily cashed our Thurs night College Marquee as the Tar Heels finally played a complete gm and beat Duke 45-20 (+6) winning the Victory Bell & becoming bowl elig for the 7th str ssn. Look for the Heels to pick up another rivalry win here but we lost all value w/LW's results.

NORTHWESTERN by 7 over Illinois - In the last 17 years, NW is 10-7 SU and 11-6 ATS. UI had won in both '10 and '11 but LTH NW drilled them 50-14 (-19'). LY NW was up 37-27 when UI got a td with 2:31 left to get under the spread (+3) in their 37-34 loss. This gm means a lot more than it did a few wks ago as the winner here gets to bowl elig. NW pulled the huge upset over ND 2 wks ago and LW crushed Purdue 38-14 (+1). They did have to play most of the 2H w/o QB Siemian who is most likely out for this one (bkp Oliver was 5-11-85-0-0). On the other side, Illinois QB Wes Untch (was rusty) was yanked in favor of O'Toole and he would lead them to a 16-14 upset (+6) over Penn St. We were leaning w/NW heavily here prior to QB Siemian's inj as they are -28 ypg in B10 play while Illinois is -188. Also NW's rush offense has avg'd 248 rush ypg the L/2 wks while Illinois is all'g a ridiculous 350 rush ypg (6.4) on the road TY but its tough laying over a TD w/a bkp QB and 2 tms playing for the same goal.

INDIANA by 3 over Purdue - PU had been 13-3 SU in this series but LY needed a backdoor cover w/1:00 left to make their spread record 12-5 ATS. IU led 49-9 before PU did their damage vs the IU bkps (lost 56-36, +20). The visitor is now 4-1 ATS and the last time PU dropped 2 str Old Oaken Buckets was '93 & '94. The Hoosiers come in off a solid performance vs OSU LW as they led the Bucks 20-14 in the 3Q before falling 42-27 (+34'). The star of the gm was RB Coleman who had 281 yds incl a 90-yd TD run. QB Diamont has been more respectable in each of the L/2 gms. On the other side, Purdue was hammered by NW 38-14 (-1). Both tms sitting at 3-7 needing a win for pride and we'll call for the home team by 1 who has by far the best player on the field (Coleman needs just 94 yds to get to 2,000).

APPALACHIAN ST by 17 over Idaho - First meeting. A week after the Mountaineers went on the road & pulled off a stunning upset over ASU, they did it again LW, handing UL their 1st conf loss of the ssn 35-16 (+11) as they had a 427-259 yd edge. They are still in the FBS transition stage so despite getting to 6 wins, they are ineligible to go to a bowl gm. IU enters fresh off a bye & a 34-17 (-5) loss to Troy in their FHG which was surprising since they were playing much better in recent wks. App St has won 9 str home finale's but this is their first that is lined & they are 2-2 as a HF while the Vandals are a perfect 5-0 as an AF TY. However, after going against the Mountaineers so many weeks, we have been made believers now.

Cincinnati by 6 over TEMPLE - UC is on a 4-0 SU run in this series and the visitor is a perfect 4-0 ATS. LY TU trailed only 21-20 w/5:10 left 2Q. From that point on the Owls all'd 17 unanswered being outgained 252-147 & lost 38-20 (+21). The Bearcats are off a 41-0 (-11) shutout over Conn to remain in contention in the AAC race as they all'd ssn lows of just 10 FD's & 129 tl yds. TU is fresh off a bye but lost 30-13 (+12) at PSU in their L/gm as they were held to a ssn low 8 FD's & turned the ball over 5X. Their offense has been stuck in neutral avg just 216 ypg the L/4 gms and they are -107 ypg in AAC play. UC is on a 9-5 run as an AF incl 3-0 TY & have covered 5 str gms overall. They are +115 ypg in AAC play and despite the situational edge for the Owls here (Cincy B2B road), we'll take the Bearcats.

West Virginia by 13 over Iowa St - The visitor is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series. Both meetings have gone down to the wire. The LTH ('12) WV down 24-23, got a 75 yd td pass w/6:31 left and then ISU at the WV7 fmb/d into the EZ for a tb at the end and WV won 31-24 (-2). LY WV led 31-7 at one point but ISU battled back, taking advantage of 3 WV 4Q TO's. With :53 left a td tied it and ISU won in 3OT, 52-44 (+7). WV is off a 26-20 (-2) loss vs KSU as they had 3 TO's inside KSU's 30-yd line and had a 27-16 FD edge. ISU remained winless in B12 play following their 34-31 (-1) loss vs TT as we cashed a 3★ LPS going against them. This is the 1st time Rhoads has gone 2 str ssn's here w/o a bowl but they're 6-3 SU/ATS in their FHG while the Mountaineers are on a 3-5-1 run as an AF & are just 4-8 ATS in B12 Gms. With Trickett ?, we'll back off calling for the Mountaineers big here.

ARKANSAS ST by 16 over New Mexico St - Former Big West ('93-95 & '99-'00) & SBC ('01-'04) foes. A-St went 1-6 but won the last mtg ('03), 28-24 (+15). Ark St comes in off B2B upset losses (37-32, -14 to App St and 45-27, -6 to TXST LW) and have failed to cover 4 of their L/5 gms. During that 5 gms stretch, their D is all'g 287 rush ypg. On the other side, NMSt has lost 9 str gms and has failed to cover 5 str gms. LW they fell to ULM 30-17 (+6) but on the bright side after all'g a ridiculous 343 rush ypg in their prev 8 gms, LW they only all'd 70. However, that will change here as AST is avg 234 rush ypg in SBC play and needs another win to assure itself of their 4th str bowl.

Uab by 4 over SOUTHERN MISS - SM had dominated this series winning 9 in a row from '00-'08 (5-3-1 ATS). UAB then reeled off a streak of 4 str wins (3-1 ATS). Heading into LY, SM had not won a gm in 2Y and was a 14' pt dog but for the 4th time in 5Y there was an outright upset in the series and SM not only won the game, they won 62-27 snapping a nation-long 23 gm losing streak. Interestingly on 3&g from the 3, SM opted to go for it and got a td w/10 left in the game to add to the margin, something UAB might remember here. The Golden Eagles are off a bye & are on a 7-2 SU/6-0 ATS run in their FHG, but haven't won a CUSA HG s/'11 (0-11 SU/2-9 ATS). UAB pl'd inspired LW in their 23-18 (+20) loss to Marshall as they all'd a D td w/7:35 left which proved to be the difference. A win here would make the Blazers bowl elig for the 1st time s/'04 and we have liked what we've seen most of the yr under 1st yr HC Bill Clark.

Over 33 years this play has been a reader favorite. The last 16 years the Underdog Play of the Week has recorded numerous **OUTRIGHT UPSET WINNERS (521) to the incredible record INCLUDING 4 in '13 incl 3 straight outright winners AND TWO THIS YEAR!!!!** Here is TW's Underdog Play:

Florida +10 over FLORIDA ST

The stakes are high as FSU is playing with Nat'l Title implications while Muschamp will be coaching his final gm for the Gators as he's already announced he won't lead the team in their bowl gm. The visitor is on a 3-0 SU/ATS run in this series winning each gm by DD. LY FSU led 27-0 in the 4Q as UF was held to 19 yds or less on 9 of 11 poss due to WR Burton being inj'd on the 2nd play as he was going to be used as a QB in the Wildcat formation for 35 snaps. The Seminoles escaped LW with another close call, this time a 20-17 (-19') win over BC as they hit a GW 26 yd fg w/:03 left to give them a school rec 27 str wins. However, we're not sure how many 9 lives they have left. The Gators are off a 52-3 win over an FCS school and could be much better than their 6-4 record indicates as they blew gms late vs LSU/SCar and had a huge misleading final vs Mizzou. FSU is just 1-5 as a HF TY while UF is 5-2 as an AD under Muschamp and we expect a very spirited effort (see UGA gm earlier TY).

BOISE ST by 7 over Utah St - The Mountain Div will be on the line here as the loser will be officially eliminated from the MW Title gm. In '97 UTST was -22 and only won 24-20. Since then, Boise has been favored in 10 of 11 games & is on a 11-0 SU/9-2 ATS run. LY the Aggies went 9/14 for a garbage td w/:20 left for a misleading 34-23 (+6) final score. The Bronco's are off a 63-14 (-12) win at WY as they've now scored 60+ pts in 2 of their L/3 gms. UTST is off a 41-7 (-14') win over SJSt last Friday night as they rushed for a ssn high 313 yds. Boise has won 15 str home finale's but are on an 0-5 ATS run in that role & are just 8-15 as a HF the L4Y while the Aggies are on a 17-6 run as an AD incl 1-0 TY in MWC action. Boise gets the win but tough backing them by more than a TD here vs an Top 10 D.

SAN DIEGO ST by 13 over San Jose St - From 2006-'12 SJSt was 3-0 SU/ATS. There have been 3 outright upsets the L/4 MWC gms incl LY as SDSt got a 12 yd td run with 3:22 left to pull out a 34-30 (+6) win. The Aztecs are off a 30-14 (-6) win over AF last Friday night to become bowl eligible for a 5th str yr (benefitted from 4 AF TO's) while the Spartans are off a 41-7 (+14') loss at USU as their bkp QB Jurich was inj'd on the 1st play of the gm (st'g QB Gray was already out due to inj). SDSt is on a 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS run in home finale's & SJSt is on an 0-5 run as an AD & they've lost 5 str overall ATS. We'll check the inj report later in the wk to see who starts at QB here for the Spartans but no matter who lines up behind center, expect a DD win for the Aztecs.

Washington by 6 over WASHINGTON ST - 107th all-time meeting for the Apple Cup pl'd every yr s/1921. Recently this has been a series of streaks as UW won 6 in a row from '98-'03 and WSU was 4-1 SU from '04-'08 and now UW is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS. The HT is on a 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS run & there have been 7 outright upsets the L13Y but only 1 in the L/5. LY was the 1st time s/02 that both entered w/ winning records. WSU led 10-3 at HT but UW won 27-17 (-16'). The Cougars were up 24-21 at HT LW at ASU, but went onto lose 52-31 (+16') despite QB Falk throwing for 601 yds & Wazzu having 30-16 FD & 622-330 yd edges as they turned the ball over 5X. We cashed a 2★ on these pages LW as well as our College 900 Saturday Marquee as the Huskies easily handled OSU 37-13 (-6') to become bowl elig for a 5th str ssn. This is Wazzu's Bowl gm & Leach is 2-0 SU/ATS in FHG's here, however, we came away really impressed w/the Huskies LW (should've beat Ariz on road 2 wks ago).

Baylor by 24 over Texas Tech - TT had been a perfect 15-0 SU (11-4 ATS) in this series but BU has now won 3 in a row SU/ATS. This will be the 6th str yr it's at a neutral site. LY TT led 20-7, but BU went onto win 63-34 (-27'). The Bears remain in contention for not only a B12 Title, but also a playoff birth & are off a 49-28 (-29') win over OSU, which was their 15th str home victory (heavy rains saw them run 58 times and pass 29). We loved the Bears early in the week (was our Early Bird POW given out FREE every Monday on button #9 at 347-677-1700), but when public opinion and the sharps move a line 4-5 pts in one direction, it's time to back off. LW we cashed a 3★ LPS on the Red Raiders as they pulled the outright upset at ISU 34-31 (+1'). BU is on a 5-1 ATS run on neutral fields while TT is on a 3-10 ATS run in that role and we like BU big again.

GEORGIA by 9 over Georgia Tech - UGA has won 12 of the L/13 in this series SU & has scored 30+ pts 7 str gms. The visitor, however is on a 12-2-1 ATS run. Paul Johnson beat the Bulldogs his 1st yr but has now dropped 5 in a row SU/1-4 ATS. LY UGA was w/o inj'd QB Murray & it was just the 2nd time s/97 that neither tm was ranked (10). GT led 20-7 at HT. Mason hit 22-36-291 for UGA who went onto win 41-34 (-3) in 2OT. GT is fresh off a bye and was awarded the ACC Coastal crown after Duke lost last Thurs so they will advance to the ACC champ gm next week. UGA is essentially off a bye after their 55-9 win over an FCS school. The Bulldogs are on a 4-0 SU run in home finales and have also covered their L/2, but the Yellow Jackets are 2-0 as an AD TY & are on a 4-0 SU/ATS run. If Ark beats Mizzou on Fri, then UGA will have SEC Champ gm on deck and could be peeking ahead.

Kansas St by 28 over KANSAS - This series has been uninterrupted s/1911. All you need to do is see who the HC is on the KSU sidelines. Bill Snyder takes care of business vs his rival. In 17 meetings he's an amazing 16-1 SU/ATS w/an avg win of 32 ppg!! LY KSU jumped out to a 21-10 lead & won 31-10 (-17). The Wildcats remained in contention for a B12 title following LW's 26-20 (+2) win at WV on Thurs where they outFD'd 27-16 and WV had 3 TO's inside KSU's 30). The Jayhawks meanwhile enter off a 44-7 (+25') loss at OU as they all'd a true frosh RB to re-set the week old single gm rushing record while gaining only 103 ttl yds & 7 ttl FD's. KU has now lost 32 str AG's (10-21-1 ATS) & is on a 6-14-1 run as an AD while the Wildcats are on a 13-6 run as a HF & Snyder is 36-13-1 ATS in B12 play since his return to the sidelines. Series play of week!

CALIFORNIA by 6 over Byu - This marks just the 3rd overall meeting between these schools with BYU winning twice. These tms haven't met s/the '05 Las Vegas Bowl with Cal winning 35-28 (-8). The Cougars enter essentially off a bye as they beat winless FCS Savannah St 64-0 (-56') limiting them to 6 FD & 63 ttl yds. They were on a 1-7 ATS run prior as they have lost their 2 best off ply'rs in QB Hill and RB Williams. The Golden Bears need a win to become bowl elig after losing to rival Stanford 38-17 (+6) LW despite QB Goff re-setting his school rec for pass yds in a ssn & tying the school rec for car td's. They were only outgained 418-410 but were -4 in TO's. Cal gets to bowl elig, despite the fact this is only the 3rd FBS foe they've been favored over TY.

Oregon by 16 over OREGON ST - This will be the 118th meeting in the Civil War as this series has been pl'd every yr s/1945. Oreg has won 6 str (4-2 ATS) in this series and is on an 11-1 SU run over the L12Y. While the Ducks have already locked up a P12 Title gm appearance next week, they have to win to stay alive for the CFB Playoff after LW's 44-10 win (-32') over Col. LY Oreg was off their upset loss to Arz the prev wk costing them a shot at the P12 Title game. OSU was off an embarrassing loss vs Wash losing 69-27 in their home finale. The Ducks were -23 at home, but the Beavers were up 35-30, however Oreg went 83/9 and got a 12 yd td w/:27 left to escape. The Ducks are on a 13-3 run as an AF & have covered 6 str gms overall while OSU needs a win to become bowl eligible and are 1-7 ATS in P12 play TY after we cashed a 2★ on these pages going against them LW in their 37-13 loss (+6') to Wash. While everything here says Oreg should win and win big, LY's gm and rivalry week altogether has us leery of laying a huge number here.

Michigan St by 13 over PENN ST - PSU is 8-3 SU s/00 in this series. These schools haven't met s/2010, which was also in Happy Valley in the rec ssn finale. MSU never trailed and won 28-22 (-1). The last time the Spartans won 2 str was in 1965-'66. PSU is off a 16-14 (-6') loss at Illinois as they all'd the GW 36 yd fg w/:08 left as we cashed our 2nd str Early Marquee Totals play (brand new play released on Fridays for \$12 on your VIP Debit system). MSU is off a 45-3 (-22) win over Rutgers as they led 35-0 at HT. The Nittany Lions are on a 1-3 SU/1-3-1 ATS run in their home finale, but are 2-0 as a HD the L3Y while the Spartans are 16-4-1 as an AF under Dantonio incl an 11-2 run. Against 5

common foes the Nittany Lions are 2-3 SU/1-4 ATS, -1 ppg & +23 ypg while MSU is 4-1 SU/ATS, +23 ppg & +236 ypg. Tough seeing a PST offense that is avg just 15 ppg in B10 play having any type of success here as MSU could be playing for a major bowl.

ALABAMA by 9 over Auburn - Aub had won 6 str Iron Bowls from '02-'07 but then Bama took control of the series, going 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS with their only loss being to Cam Newton in '10. LY Bama was #1 and Aub #4 and it was the highest ranked Iron Bowl in history. Aub ran 52x for 296 yds on the vaunted Bama D & with the gm tied w/:01 left, the Tide's 57 yd fg fell short & the Tigers ret'd it 109.5 yds for the win in one of the most famous plays in CFB history. Both tms enter fresh off what essentially were byes as both pl'd FCS programs. Bama is on a 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS run in their FHG & is on an 8-5 run as a HF, while Aub is on just a 2-6 ATS run vs FBS foes but Malzahn is 3-1 as an AD incl 2 outright upsets. While we think Bama is the best tm in the country, their lines have been inflated in recent yrs (were 35-19 overall ATS from '08-'11) and now they are just 3-7 ATS TY. They are incredibly +302 ypg at home TY (just +26 ypg on road) while Aub is -15 ypg on road (+167 ypg at home). No doubt, the Tide want revenge from LY's finish but can't lay too many here as Aub has nothing to lose.

Nevada by 13 over UNLV - Battle for the Freemont Cannon & this marks the 1st time s/1977 that this rivalry will be pl'd at the end of the ssn. UNLV has lost 8 of the L/9 meetings (3-6 ATS) but did win for the 1st time s/'04 LY. There were 6 lead changes & the Rebels scored the GW td after a fumble recovery to win 27-22 (+6). NV did have a 39-18 FD edge. HC Polian was not as maniacal as Chris Ault about the rivalry but after losing LY, over the winter they installed a clock counting down the seconds in the locker room to the next meeting. The Wolf Pack saw their MW hopes die after losing at home to FSU 40-20 (-7) while the Rebels enter off a 37-35 (+10) loss at Haw cashing another winner for our Big Dogs. Hauck is 13-7-1 as a HD but we expect Nevada to bounce back (4-1 ATS on the road TY).

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 9 over ULM - This is the 5th meeting between these schools & the series is tied 2-2, but this is their 1st meeting s/1991. GS is fresh off a bye but were crushed 52-19 (+3) at Navy in their L/4 gm. ULM is off a 30-17 (-8) win at NMSt. GS has won 5 straight FHG, but this is their 1st lined gm in that role. This is the 4th AG in 5W incl the 2nd of B2B for the Warhawks. Against 5 common foes the Eagles are 5-0 SU/2-3 ATS, +17 ppg & +79 ypg while ULM is 3-2 SU/2-3 ATS, +3 ppg & +17 ypg. ULM's run D has been gashed in recent wks while Ga Southern's option off is avg 444 rush ypg (7.6) at home TY. However, they are laying 2 td's here and Vegas oddsmakers have caught up to them in recent wks (2-4 ATS run) while ULM is 3-0-1 ATS in their L/4 gms.

FRESNO ST by 12 over Hawaii - These schools have pl'd every yr s/'92. UH was 4-1 SU/ATS in this series from '06-'10, but FSU has now won 3 str (2-1 ATS). There have been 3 outright upsets the L6Y & you would figure any time UH plays the home field would be big, but the visitor is actually on a 7-2 SU/ATS run. LY FSU was off their big win over Boise & led 42-3 mid-3Q but UH pulled within 5 & had the ball but was int'd at the 3 w/:06 left from the 45. The Bulldogs are off a 40-20 (+7) win in Nev which means a win here will give them the West div Title. The Rainbow Warriors are off a 37-35 (-10) win vs UNLV giving them B2B MW wins. FSU is on a 3-1 SU/ATS run in home finales & this will be the 1st time in UH's history that they will end their reg ssn on the road. Also notable is the fact that Fresno is playing just their 4th gm in 42 days while UH plays their 7th.

Utah by 6 over COLORADO - Both of these schools joined the P12 in '11. Utah is 2-1 SU incl B2B wins but CU is 3-0 ATS. LY Utah (-15) led 21-0 at HT, but CU pulled within 24-17 w/2:30 left. Utah rec'd the outside kick but punted and CU was int'd at their own 21. The Buff's are off a 44-10 (+32') loss at Oregon while the Utes are off a 42-10 (-4') loss vs Ariz. CU has lost 4 of their L/6 home finales but have covered 8 str in that role. MacIntyre is 8-3 ATS at Folsom Field incl 3-1 as a HD TY, while UT is on a 1-4 ATS run as an AF. Look for the Buffs to make it a 4 str covers over the Utes.

MEMPHIS by 21 over Connecticut - LY was the 1st meeting between these schools. The Huskies dominated leading 21-3 at HT & rolled to a 45-10 (+1) win with a 538-257 yd edge. The 35 pt MOV was Conn's largest in a conf gm as a FBS program. MEM has a large ST edge and is playing at home with legit revenge. The Tigers are off a 31-20 (-18') win over USF (Bulls got a 4th Dn td pass late) and need a win here to lock up at least a share of the AAC Title. The Huskies are off a 41-0 (+11) loss to Cincy as they were shutout at home for 1st time s/'1978 and were outgained 248-9 in the 1H. One of the conf's best vs one of the worst and we look for an easy Tiger win here.

LOUISVILLE by 13 over Kentucky - The Governor's Cup will be on the line as this rivalry has been pl'd every yr s/'94. The gm has been pl'd early in the ssn but now it's the final gm. UK had won 4 in a row from '07-'10 but UL has now won 3 in a row SU (2-0-1 ATS). In the L/18 meetings, the tm w/the most rush yds has taken the Governor's Cup. That's not good news for the Wildcats as they are avg just 87 (2.7) rush ypg while all'g 228 (4.6) on the road while the Cards avg 199 (4.8) rush ypg while all'g just 78 (3.0) at home & rushed for an FBS ssn high 229 LW vs ND. LY the line opened with UL laying 7 but it kept climbing all week & by gametime it was up to -14. It was tied at 10 at HT but the Cardinals dominated the 2H and won 27-13. The Wildcats have a significant situation edge as they are fresh off while UL is off a big road trip to South Bend. UK was trounced 50-16 (+10) at Tenn in their L/4 gm, which was their 5th str loss. The Cardinals enter off a 31-28 (+3') win at ND, cashing a 3★ on these pages. This is the Cardinals FHG and they are surprisingly in on an 0-6 ATS run in that role and we'll give a slight lean to the underdog Cats here.

OLE MISS by 1 over Mississippi St - Has there been a more important Egg Bowl in recent history? A win here could give MSU a spot in the CFB Playoff. Dan Mullen is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series but the HT is on a 9-1 SU/7-2-1 ATS run. LY Mullen's job was on the line and MSU was a 4 pt HD. The story of the game was 3rd string Bulldog QB Damian Williams making his 1st start as Prescott & bkp Russell were inj'd. Trailing 10-7 mid 3Q Prescott came off the bench even though he was not supposed to play. MSU missed a GW 39 yd fg on the final play of regulation but in OT, Ole Miss QB Wallace had the ball knocked loose at the 3 and it rolled in the EZ for a TB as the Bulldogs won 17-10 (-4). The Rebels are off a 30-0 (-3) loss at Ark as we cashed our 3.5★ LPS play on the UNDER. The gm was very misleading as Ole Miss had a 316-311 yd edge but a 6-1 TO deficit that incl a 100-yd IR td. MSU is off a 51-0 (-29) win over Vandy and got 10 wins for the 1st time in schl history. It was also their largest SEC win s/1936. LW's misleading final and MSU's late comeback vs Bama 2 wks ago gives us a little value here and we'll take the HT by the slimmest of margins.

4★ INDIANAPOLIS by 23 over Washington - IND has a commanding situational edge at home for the 3rd straight with a proven QB that is 17-5 SU/15-8 ATS at home. LW provides good value here as while the Colts won, they didn't blow out the Jaguars who's defense put the bye to good use holding Luck to 112 yds with 5 sks in the 1H. In the 2H he had 141 yds (73%) 1-0 and wasn't sacked again. WAS covered vs SF despite Griffin's 106 yds (58%) effort getting sacked 5 times with Gruden complimenting the rest of the team on their effort, except the passing game. Griffin is 0-7 SU/ 1-6 ATS on the road avg 221 ypg (59%) 7-5 and an unimpressive 6.88 ypa. WAS has the #10 defense but have only faced one top 10 offense and that was DAL with Weeden starting. Vs Foles, Eli and Palmer and Wilson the Redskins allowed 269 ypg (68%) 11-1 for a 117.6 QBR. IND is 5-0 SU/ATS vs foes with a losing record TY and expect Luck to show that while Griffin may have won the Heisman its pretty clear who is winning as an NFL starter.

3★ HOUSTON by 10 over Tennessee - HOU is 7-2 SU/9-3 ATS vs the Titans who are 2-7 ATS on the road. HOU thumped TEN 30-16 in the 1st meeting as a 3 pt AF in Mettenberger's 1st start holding TEN to 188 yds before pulling back in the 4Q with a 21 pt lead. This is a poor spot for the Titans who are on their 3rd road game in 4 weeks with the MNF loss vs PIT their only home game. TEN has been outgained by 91 ypg in Mettenberger's 4 starts while giving up 183 ypg (5.0) rushing. HOU is 3-1 SU/ATS vs foes with a losing record TY (only loss on 2nd of B2B coastal trips) and this is just the 2nd game since Sept for HOU vs a sub-.500 foe. HOU came back to earth LW as they couldn't run the ball and Mallett didn't have as much success with big plays (4.2. ypa 4 plays over 15 yards). TEN lost FS Griffin (disloc shoulder) LW and HOU's troubles vs the run LW was due to CIN's above avg DL. This is the 1st time HOU is a fav over a FG but they also go from an experienced CIN unit to a TEN team that's had too many changes on both sides of the ball to be competitive.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SAN FRANCISCO by 4 over Seattle - Thurs. SEA has covered 5 straight including LY's playoff victory (23-13 avg score) thanks to Lynch who's avg'd 96 ypg (4.1) rushing and their defense. Wilson has only avg'd 170 ypg (56%) with a 7-4 ratio and a total of 74 yds rush (3.0). Kaepernick has been held to 175 ypg passing (52%) 3-7 while avg 70 ypg (7.8) rushing in his 4 starts vs SEA. The Seahawks, without C Unger, are off physical matchups vs KC/ARZ and now face SF who has 17 sacks in the L6 games. LW SEA gave up 7 sacks at home to ARZ as they only have 1 receiver with over 400 yds TY (Baldwin who has 47% of the yds Tate has with DET TY). Wilson is only avg 188 ypg (61%) with a 4-3 ratio the L5 games which is fine vs CAR, OAK, NYG travelling off MNF and ARZ with Stanton but not on the road on a short week.

2★ BALTIMORE by 9 over San Diego - BAL may be off their MNF game vs the Saints but they are 34-13 ATS as a NDIV HF (3-0 TY) and this is the 1st road game for SD in 4 weeks. BAL is 4-1 SU/ATS at home TY and is +85 ypg at home (+1 TO) while SD is -85 ypg (-4 TOs) on the road. The Chargers found themselves in a battle LW and after trailing at halftime came away with a 3 pt win. They now however travel cross county and we'll continue to play against them as they have dropped 6 straight against the spread. The Chargers have especially struggled getting a pass rush on the road as in their last 3 games they've been shut out in sacks which is a concern as the Ravens are 4-0 SU/ATS when Flacco stays clean and BAL has avg'd 34 points in those games. The edge that the Ravens have with their DL makes this a star rated play as they have an outstanding 20 sacks in their last 5 games (prior to NO) while the banged up SD OL has allowed 13 in their last 5 games.

THANKSGIVING DAY:

DETROIT by 9 over Chicago - The Lions ended a 10 year SU losing run on Thanksgiving LY improving to 2-8 ATS in their showcase game. CHI hasn't faced the Lions on Thanksgiving since 1999 and are 1-5-1 ATS in Thursdays. Cutler has only avg'd 219 ypg (54%) 5-4 in his L5 vs the Lions with Forte rushing for 78 ypg (4.1). The Bears have done a solid job of containing Megatron with 5 straight games under 100 yds rec (25 rec 12.6) but they are off a big game vs their former coach on a short week where they were greatly outplayed but were gifted with 4 TO's that they turned into 14 pts. DET has been shown the L2W what it means to play solid defense and explosive offense and found lacking. They are now behind GB in the NFC North standings as with Bush and Megatron hurting they have no playmakers outside of Golden Tate on offense (Stafford 76 pass att 0 TD's L2W). We'll call for the home team to break out as the Lions face a team with comparable talent on a short week at home here.

Philadelphia at DALLAS - The Cowboys have failed to cover 3 straight on Thanksgiving to teams that had 4 or fewer wins when they met. The dog is 6-2 ATS in this series with DAL losing at home LY in the season finale to a Div rival for the 3rd straight year. Romo was out with his back injury and PHI had a 137 (4.0) to 56 (3.1) rushing edge that was backed by winning the field position game (DAL 29.0 punt net avg). DAL has the edge with the better run game TY with Murray & a more consistent QB situation with Romo. DAL is the 9th team to play on SNF then Thursday and are 6-13 ATS as a Div favorite. PHI got right vs a Titans with a rookie QB on the road off MNF and the quality of that victory is dubious at best. Without seeing how DAL fared off their bye week on SNF we'll hold off on this.

Sunday Nov 30

Cleveland by 1 over BUFFALO - This is the 7th meeting in 8 years with LY's matchup having a huge impact on both teams. CLE won LY's meeting 37-24 as a 4 pt HF but Hoyer tore his ACL and CLE would go onto win just 1 other game. BUF lost EJ Manuel (knee) and Marrone hasn't had confidence in him since. BUF is dealing with their relocated MNF game vs the Jets but this is the 3rd road game in 4 Wks for CLE and even with byes mixed in teams are 9-21 ATS in that spot TY. Pettine was the Bills DC LY and knows the basics of Marrone's offense. CLE outplayed ATL LW except for Hoyer's 3 miscues with a 160 yd edge and Gordon was featured with 120 yds (15.0). That provided some much needed balance and CLE outshouted ATL 162 (5.6) 63 (2.7) and now face a BUF team that is allowing 146 ypg (5.3) its L4 games. We'll call for the Browns by 1 with the disruption in the Bills schedule and CLE also being a cold weather team with an intriguing rush attack.

NY Giants by 6 over JACKSONVILLE - The Giants come in off a tough 5 week stretch vs foes that are a combined 36-18 prior to the SNF. The Giants have lost the yardage battle in six straight largely due to their rush defense which has allowed 191 ypg (5.4) the L5. Add in the fact that the Giants only have 17 sacks TY (#28) and the Giants have lost their team identity that Coughlin built. JAX is 2-8-1 ATS TY due to their woeful offense which gained 53% of their 194 yds on their final 2 drives vs IND. Bortles (70.8 QBR 8-15 ratio 1 fbl) is not having quite as bad a rookie tour as Gabbert (65.4 QBR 12-11 ratio 15 fbls) but its close due to bad pass protection and no weapons. JAX is also running the SEA defense which Manning just faced 3 Wks ago (283

UTEP by 7 over Middle Tennessee - MT is playing their 2nd road gm in 3W while UTEP is playing its home finale. This is UTEP's 6th str game while MT has had 2 byes in that span. This is MT's first trip to this site in a rare altitude game. The Miners are coming off a 31-13 (+10) loss at Rice where they were held to a ssn low 53 rush yds as we cashed our Fri Night Marquee on the UNDER but unfortunately dropped a 4★ Key Selection on these pages. The Blue Raiders are off a wild 35-34 (-7) win over FAU as we liked their LOS matchup prior to the gm and the fact they needed a win to get to bowl. However, they trailed most of the gm and got a 4th & G1 12-yd td pass w/19 left. Just 2 wks ago here, UTEP cashed as our 5★ GOY and we'll back them here as MT greatly disappointed us LW.

Louisiana by 7 over TROY - This will be the final gm of Troy HC Blakeney's career after announcing mid ssn that this would be his final yr after 24 yrs at the helm. When Troy was an SBC power, they had 5 straight wins in this series from '06-10 (4-1 ATS), but UL has now won 3 in a row SU (2-1 ATS, 2 outright upsets). The HT is on a 4-2 SU/2-4 ATS run. LY Troy finished with a 469-378 yd edge & 27-19 FD edge, but couldn't become bowl elig as on 4&g1 from the 4, their pass was batted down with 2:01 left and lost 41-36 (+14). UL is off a 35-16 (-11) loss vs App St, which was their 1st loss in SBC play. The Trojans are fresh off a bye and scored an outright upset over ID 34-17 (+5) in their L/gm. Troy has won 5 of 6 FHG's by 20 pgg and we expect an all-out effort here while UL could still be reeling from LW's shocking loss.

yds 66% 1-1) and the only WR with 500 yds for JAX is on IR. The Jaguars may have the situational edge but we can't side with a team that's 3-10 ATS at home or 4-14 ATS vs a NDIV foe under Bradley.

Cincinnati by 6 over TAMPA BAY - This is the 3rd straight road game for the Bengals who have a huge showdown vs PIT on deck (17-7-1 ATS prior). CIN is 1-5 ATS as an AF but have taken care of business vs the NFC South (2-1 ATS) with a 463-357 yd edge with a 29-19 avg score. Dalton has avg'd 265 ypg (73%) 6-2 vs them (113.6 QBR) while the Bucs have given up 312 ypg (69%) with a 10-2 ratio (121.4 QBR) and the AFC North are the only foes that own a winning record TB has faced TY. The Bucs are moving the ball well (358 ypg L4W vs 295 prior) but have self-destructed off TO's (LW +163 yds but -3 TO's) or special teams. CIN is 5-0-1 ATS vs foes with a losing record right now (+79 yds) with a 29-17 avg score. With the Bucs being off an emotionally draining loss to their HC/QB we'll lean with the road team here that is building momentum.

ST LOUIS by 7 over Oakland - The Raiders secured their first win in a calendar year (0-6 ATS afterwards) with #3 RB Murray's 112 yds rushing in the win being 13.8% of OAK's season total. OAK has gone out of their way to protect Carr who had 5 straight games with a ypa below 5.9. OAK is a surprising 4-1 ATS on the road TY despite being outgained by 77 ypg (-6 TO's) with Carr avg 204 ypg (59%) 5-3 with just a 5.23 ypa! The most an OAK player has rushed for on the road TY is 59 yds (McFadden vs NE/CLE) while 119 ypg (3.7) on the road. STL proved once again they can play with anyone provided their DL shows up (16 sks 66 ypg 3.5 ypc L4W) vs SD. The Rams were in position to win the game with 2nd and goal at the SD 4 but Hill was INT in the EZ to cap off a day where he had 198 yds (51%) with a 1-1 ratio prior to that. The Rams have the talent in the trenches here but trusting this many points to a team that lost their only role as a fav TY back in Wk 1 to a rookie HC has us call for a TD and watch the line.

PITTSBURGH by 6 over New Orleans - The Steelers return from their bye but are just 2-5 ATS as a NDIV HF. PIT is 4-2 SU/3-3 ATS vs sub-.500 teams with a 382-320 yd edge failing to cover vs the Jets and Titans. However, that was after a 3 game home stretch with 2 primetime games and IND minus 3 defensive starters. Roethlisberger has dominated at home with 370 ypg (73%) 19-1 and while Brees is putting up decent yardage with 310 ypg (68%) he only has an 8-5 ratio on the road TY. NO is 0-7 SU/1-6 ATS away vs NDIV foe are 1-4 ATS vs 3-4 oriented defenses (ATL ran it in Wk 1) TY. This is a poor setup for NO on the road on a grass surface on a short week in potentially cold weather and we'll take the home team with a manageable line.

Carolina by 3 over MINNESOTA - CAR is 1-4 ATS after a bye and 2-5 ATS on the road. They sorely needed the bye to settle their OL which has Newton registering his worst season as a pro with a 80.3 QBR. Newton has been sacked 21 times in his L5 games and outside of Benjamin (52 rec 14.8) the Panthers have limited speed at WR. The problem for CAR has been depth not starting talent and defensively they are allowing 87 ypg (3.1) rushing the L4 which is about what they allowed in 2013. MIN played GB tough holding them to better than half what the Packers scored in their L2 games. The Vikings also own the #4 pass rush (31 sks) but minus the STL/TB game are allowing 130 ypg rush (4.5). MIN is playing safe with Bridgewater who has 6 straight games with a ypa of 6.4 or less with just a 6-7 ratio on the year. Both teams are in a down year but we'll side the more dynamic road team getting points here.

Arizona by 3 over ATLANTA - The Falcons deserve credit as after blowing a 3Q, 21-0 lead in London and going into their bye week at 2-6 they've reeled off 2 wins. Even with their loss to CLE LW they remain in the hunt for the NFC South. Ryan has quietly played solid ball the L4W with 247 ypg (67%) 6-2 and LW's loss was due to bad clock management by HC Smith again. ATL is 0-7 SU/2-6 ATS vs NDIV foes TY being outgained 437-323 but find themselves in a plus situation. They catch ARZ after a draining loss where they sacked Wilson 7 times, held Lynch to 39 yds rush (2.6) but still lost. This is the 1st time Stanton starts B2B games and while he hasn't been sacked at home he's been sacked 8 times on the road TY. ARZ has been held under 65 yds rushing in 3 straight games (46 ypg 2.0) which is fine with Palmer and a 100% Fitzgerald. The Cardinals defense deserves every accolade its earned and matchup well vs an ATL offense that struggles to run (#26) and we'll call for the road team by a FG.

New England by 3 over GREEN BAY - This is the 1st ever meeting between Brady and Rodgers as starters. GB gets the situational nod at home where Rodgers is avg 283 ypg (67%) 18-0 with a fantastic 9.81 ypa (138.1 QBR). NE is 1-3 ATS vs foes with a winning record being outgained by 52 ypg but are +9 TO's which is what makes them hard to beat (Packers only 1 game with negative TO margin TY). GB's #24 defense has only faced 2 teams with a top 10 offense losing to NO and beating PHI with Sanchez travelling off a MNF game. NE has won 4 straight vs foes that own a winning record right now (lost to MIA/KC) and in those wins are +99 ypg, outrushing them 155 (4.6) to 58 (3.0) with a 41-17 avg score. Yes GB is 4-1 ATS as a HF TY but they have faced Geno Smith, Ponder, Newton with a horrible OL, Cutler who they own and Sanchez in his 2nd start with PHI. We'll side with the veteran QB that's used to the big games and quietly backed by one of the deepest secondary's in the NFL (82.0 QBR).

Denver at KANSAS CITY - SEVEN points, did we really watch Manning and the Broncos get held to that their last road game. Well that can happen when you on a third straight road trip and now they travel for a 4th time in 5 weeks. Arrowhead will be rocking as this is only their 2nd primetime home game in 3 years and in their other early this season they man-handled NE 41-14. The Chiefs have confidence as they outgained DEN 380-325 at Mile High but were stopped on 4&goal on the 2 with :15 left.

Miami at NY JETS - Monday. Situational edge goes to the Jets having played last Monday in a neutral setting while Miami is on the difficult and long B2B away trip off Denver. The visitor however, has covered the last 5 in this series including pulling the upset the last 3 games. In Michaels Vick's 2 starts (prior to MN) the team has outgained KC on the road and beat Pittsburgh with the most obvious change being +4 in TO's the pair of games versus a -15 TO margin their first 8. Can the Dolphins handle an "almost must win" with BAL and NE on deck or will Ryan and company play spoiler?

UTSA by 3 over North Texas - These schools met for the 1st time LY. NT had been playing great in Apogee Stadium but UTSA never trailed. The Mean Green had 1&G1 from the Roadrunner 3 but threw an int in the EZ on the final play to lose 21-13 (-7). After 2 strong 2013 campaigns, these are the 2 biggest disappointments in CUSA TY as both never even threatened bowl elig. NT is off a 17-14 (-2) win over FIU while UTSA is off a 45-7 (+10) loss at WKU. NT has been a far diff tm away from Apogee TY (+73 ypg at home, -189 away) and we'll back the HT by a FG in what should be a low scoring snooze fest.

USC by 10 over Notre Dame - USC won 8 in a row SU from '02-'09 despite the fact that both teams were ranked in 4 of the 8 meetings. ND is now 3-1 SU/ATS since and the HT is 1-4 SU. LTH ND was #1 in the country and USC dropped a td pass from the 1 at the end and lost 22-13 (+5). LY USC missed a fg then passed up 2 others and lost 14-10 (+3) on the road. Both tms are 7-4 and just playing for pride at this pt. LW USC was dominated for much of the gm vs UCLA in their 38-20 loss (+4) as they were outgained 461-276 which incl a USC late 91-yd drive for a TD. On the other side, after a 6-0 start, the Irish have dropped 4 of 5 incl the L/2 gms by a FG. LW we went against them on these pages w/a 3★ Key Selection on Louisville and the Cards led a majority of the gm and had a 409-335 yd edge in the 31-28 win. Both tms are depleted due to inj and scholarship limitations but ND's depth shy and extremely young D has all'd at least 31 pts in 6 str gms and we can't see them slowing down a USC offense that is avg 43 ppg at home TY.
