In 2008 the Vandals hosted the Broncos losing 51-28 (-8) and they ret'd the favor winning 33-13 (-3) in Kalamazoo in 2010. After having their opener susp'd due to weather vs Florida, ID traveled to ULM LW and nearly pulled the outright upset, allowing the GW td w/:09 left to fall 38-31 (+14). This is a much improved tm with 17 ret str's and many incoming JUCO's. WM is off a bye after losing at PU 43-34 (+8) despite having 24-22 FD and 456-407 yd edges. However, that performance was lessened greatly after we watched Purdue get rolled by C Mich LW by 3 td's. This is the 1st time WM has traveled this far west since their '08 matchup here. Another added edge to ID here is the fact that they hired former UMass HC Charlie Molnar as WR cch and he played W Mich LY and has knowledge of the team. Also add in the fact, we won a Underdog POW on these pages LY with ID at home vs a tm travelling across the country early in the ssn (beat Temple 26-24, +7). The Vandals roll here.

**FORECAST: IDAHO by 14**

**3★ MARYLAND over West Virginia** - LY's game was played in Baltimore and it was our "Almost 5★". The game was played in a steady downpour and the Terps got their most lopsided win in the series s/'51. WV had won 7 in a row SU (5-2 ATS) yet the Terps were -3. MD led 30-0 at HT. MD's DC Brian Stewart spent 2 ssn at UH where the Cougars used the offense that Holgersen installed in '08 to '09. They held WV to 175 tl yds and the 37 pt MOV was a series high s/'51. Both tms look to be improved TY as the Terps are 2-0 and survived a scare vs USF LW 24-17 (-13) despite having 6 TO's. WV, after giving Bama all they could handle in the opener, whipped Towson 54-0 (-28) as they posted 34-7 FD and 606-122 yd edges. QB Trickett is one of the MIP QB's in the entire country avg 357 ypg (75%) w/a 3-0 ratio. The Terps do have the D edge (#24-66) and should be able to come away with a DD win as it's tough getting LY's domination out of our heads.

**FORECAST: MARYLAND By 10**

**3★ CENTRAL MICHIGAN over Syracuse** - The only prior meeting took place in '99 as CM lost 47-7 (+30) in the Carrier Dome. This is a rare non-conf home gm vs a FBS foe for the Chippewas as they are 1-4 SU the L11Y with the win coming in '07 (47-23, -14 vs Army). SU is 2-12 SU/4-9 ATS s/'00 in 'true' road openers. Since '00, SU has started a ssn 2-0 just once ('11) but after barely surviving FCS Villanova in the opener 27-26 (-15) in 2OT, they will be up against it here vs a very exp'd and talented CM tm fresh off a 38-17 (+3) upset over Purdue LW. Mich trans RB Thomas Rawls has been the MVP so far with 2 100+-yd efforts and his presence is even more important considering the Chips were playing w/o WR Titus Davis LW (CS). On the other side, it will be interesting to see how Cuse QB Terrel Hunt rebounds after getting ejected in the Nova gm for throwing a punch. Look for this one to go down to the wire and we think CM is perfectly capable of notching their 2nd str win over a Power 5 school.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Army (+) over STANFORD** - These two faced off LY for the 1st time s/'79 as the situation favored Army and David Shaw had SU on a tourist trip at Michie Stadium. Army led 6-0 early but SU was up 17-13 at the half. SU finally got some distance in the 2H and led 34-13 before Army got a 6 yd td w/:17 left. SU is off a physical gm against USC where they let a 10-7 HT lead slip away and lost 13-10 (-3) despite 21-16 FD and 413-291 yd edges (-2 TO's). Army meanwhile pl'd their 1st gm of the ssn LW and was up 47-17 4Q before allowing Buff to score 22 str pts to make it interesting as we cashed a 3★ Key Selection winner on these pages. The Black Knights were a perfect 7-7-125 throwing the ball and RB Dixon rushed for 20-174-2. We question what frame of mind Stanford will be in here after LW's disappointment while Army is fully capable of shortening the gm and pulling a backdoor just like LY.

**FORECAST: STANFORD by 21**

**2★ TCU over Minnesota** - These teams have only one prior meeting with UM winning 9-7 in '74. UM is off a much tougher than expected 35-24 (-16) win over MTSU. After going up 28-0 at HT, the Gophers were outscored 24-7 in the 2H and were outFD'd 23-18 & outgained 445-351 in the gm. TCU is off a bye and has another bye on deck so this should be a "A" performance especially as they try to continue to put LY's 4-8 ssn behind them. In their opener TCU had a 555-143 yd edge in their 48-14 (-31) win against overmatched Samford. The Horned Frogs are on an 8-0 ATS run off a bye and look for them to dominate here.

**Louisiana Tech at NORTH TEXAS** - LT had won their 2 prev meetings both SU/ATS but that was in '05 and '06. LY in their first conf game, NT was -3 at LT. LT jumped out to a 10-0 lead but NT got a 61 yd td pass and a 56 yd IR td within 2:48 to lead 14-10 at the half and scored td's on two 3Q poss to blow it open, 28-10. The FD were even at 20 and LT had a 404-396 yd edge. This is LT's 3rd str road game while NT is home for A 2nd str gm. LW the Mean Green smashed SMU 43-6 (-2) as we cashed a 3★ LPS Totals play on the OVER. Speaking of cashing plays, we had LT as a 2★ on these pages and also a 4★ LPS LW and they easily dispatched Louisiana 48-20 (+15). Both tms are coming off in-state foes and gave big efforts. **Houston at BYU** - LY (only prior meeting) we had a 3★ Key Selection on UH (+10) on these pages and they could have easily gotten a home win. The gm featured 2 ties, 8 lead changes and neither tm led by more than 10. BYU led 41-40 but all'd a 84/7pl td and trailed by 5 w/5:20 left. BYU got a GW 11 yd td pass (2ptng) w/1:08 LEFT (UH was int'd next pl). While UH is travelling on a short wk, playing in elevation, BYU is coming off B2B long road trips and just gave an A+ effort against Texas LW (41-7, -1) and UH is only off FCS Grambling St (47-0, -47). Will this one come down to the wire for the 2nd yr in a row or is BYU the best Non-Power 5 conf tm TY? **Pick up our Thurs Night Marquee on Gameday after Noon ET on your VIP Debit system for just \$12.**

**Friday, September 12th**

**Toledo at CINCINNATI** - The Bearcats will play all their HG's at Paul Brown Stad TY (home of CIN Bengals). UC has dropped 3 str in the series incl a 29-23 loss (+6) in the L/gm ('12) as UC was 5-0 and ranked #21. UC trailed 13-0 but took their only lead 20-19 w/2:08 3Q. They all'd a 91 yd KR td :13 sec later. UT is 2-9 SU in road openers (0-8 not involving a MAC opp) but they have cashed each of their 4T. The Rockets will already be playing in their 3rd gm (off a 49-24 loss (+3) to Miz-zou) while UC is the last tm in the country to start the 2014 ssn as they had 2 byes to start. Can the Rockets take adv of their 2 GUB adv or will UC get revenge for 2012? **Pick up our Fri Night Marquee on Gameday after Noon ET on your VIP Debit system for just \$12.**

**Baylor at BUFFALO** - These two have meet 3x s/'07 and the Bears are a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS winning by an avg of 46-13 (-15). LY while Bears QB Bryce Petty hit just 13 of 16 passes, amazingly the 13 comp went for 388 yds (29.8 ypc). Buffalo had just given a big effort the previous wk vs Ohio St and Baylor's str's played just 46 pl but had 576 yds of offense being pulled on the first series of the 3Q. The game was just 21-13 w/2:11 left 1Q but after that Baylor had a 42-0 edge finishing with a 781-363 yd edge (70-13, -27). LW they beat FCS NWSU 70-6 (-47) as QB Petty sat out (back. CS here). LW we cashed a 3★ on these pages playing against Buffalo and they lost 47-39 (+3) to Army and at one pt trailed 47-17. This will be the first time in UB history a FB HG will air on ESPN. 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**Saturday, September 13th**

**Indiana by 8 over BOWLING GREEN** - LY (school's 1st meeting) IU was -2' at home but dominated the game. In fact, BG's only td came when they took the ball off the foot of the punter and ret'd it for the td. IU won 42-10 with 601 yds of offense and QB Nate Sufeld avg 19.7 ypp vs BG hitting 17-26-335. TY IU comes in fresh off a bye after their 28-10 win (-31) over Indiana ST which saw them have a 455-30 rush yd edge led by RB Tevin Coleman's 247 (10.7). While BG is off a 48-7 (-38) win over VMI LW, they suffered a huge loss during the wk as their All-MAC QB Matt Johnson is OFY (hip). After having the MAC's best D in each of the L/2 yrs, they have been shockingly awful TY especially their pass D as they have all'd 445 pass ypg (68%) w/a 6-1 ratio. That's not good news going against an Indiana pass off that avg'd 307 pass ypg a year ago.

**MARSHALL by 21 over Ohio** - These two are becoming each other's biggest rivals. MU had won 6 in a row SU from '01-'10 but OU has now won 3 in a row SU. The HT is 3-0 ATS and 9-3-1 ATS L/13. In '12 OU was -6' at MU. MU led 24-17 but OU got a fg w/1:37 left to pull out the win after a 48 yd IR. LY MU dominated statistically with 28-19 FD and 482-335 yd edges but could not overcome a -4 TO deficit and lost 34-31 (-7) on the road. LY MU won their HG's by an avg of 52-13 and OU lost on the road by an avg of 32-21 and now are on their 3rd straight AG. The Herd are off a 48-7 win (-41) over Rhode Island as they notched a 724-175 yd edge incl a 432-64 rush yd edge. LW we cashed a 4★ Key Selection on these pages going against Ohio as the game wasn't as close as the 20-3 final (+13) as Kentucky led 17-0 at HT and had a 402-223 yd edge. Ohio is now 1-7 ATS as an AD while Marshall is 6-0-1 as a HF. Technical, series and talent edges say the Herd get revenge in a big way here.

**MISSOURI By 6 over Ucf** - In the only prior gm, MU won in Orlando 21-16 (+2) in '12. MU trailed 10-7 at HT but went up by 11 w/9:31 left. Uf 5, MU forced a fmb! at the UCF42 (ran out L/2:29). MU had a 80 yd td pass, a 66 yd PR td and were outFD'd 27-16 and outgained 395-346. UCF is 5-13 SU s/'96 (first ssn w/FBS status) in 'true' road openers but 3-1 SU the L/4 yrs and are 12-5 ATS. The Knights are off a bye after their 26-24 (-2) loss to Penn St in Ireland. The offense struggled most of the gm but was ignited by QB Justin Holman who was 9-14-204-1-0 in the 2H. The Tigers are off a 49-24 (-3) win over Toledo as QB Mauk was 21-32-325-5-2. They did only outgain the Rockets 502-410. UCF only has Bethune-Cookman and a bye on deck and coming off a bye, this game is one that will be circled for them as they keep it close throughout.

**NC State By 3 over USF** - 3rd meeting and 3rd different venue. NCSt won the '05 Car Care Bowl 14-0 (-3) but lost the L/gm ('08) 41-10 (+9). The Wolfpack are 1-7 SU/ATS in road/neutral openers incl 3 str losses. While NC State is 2-0 SU TY, they are 0-2 ATS and have struggled at home against the likes of Ga Southern and Old Dominion as they have trailed in the 2H of both games. LW they rallied from a 21-10 deficit to beat ODU 46-34 (-16) as the FD's were even at 28 while ODU had a 504-495 yd edge. USF, on the other hand, lost to Maryland 24-17 (+13) despite the Terps gift-wrapping them 6 TO's. The Bulls did lose QB Mike White to an arm inj on the 1H and his replacement Steven Bench was just 14-36-162-0-1. RB Mack who had 275 rush in the opener was held to 73 (3.3). While USF doesn't have a homefield adv (7-21-1 ATS L/4 yrs), it's tough making NCSt an AF against anyone as they have dropped 15 str in that role and have gone just 2-13 SU.

**MICHIGAN by 35 over Miami, Oh** - UM is 5-0 SU vs Miami and 33-1 SU vs the MAC w/their only loss in '08 hosting Toledo. However, they are 1-3 ATS in the series and in the L/gm ('08) UM only won 16-6 (-14). In the last 10 ssn's the Wolverines are 10-0 SU the gm after rival ND but have failed to cover 3 of their L/4. It was an embarrassing performance by the Wolverines LW in the final scheduled gm vs ND as they were shutout for the 1st time in 365 gms (NCAA rec dating back to 1984) in their 31-0 loss (+3). While UM did have a 289-280 yd adv, they were -4 in TO's and never got into the ND red zone (did miss 2 FG's). After a TO free performance in the opener, Gardner had 4 and HC Hoke's seat will only get warmer as UM has not beaten a ranked tm on the road s/'06 (0-11). The RedHawks have now lost 18 str overall gms after LW's 17-10 loss (-2) to Eastern Kentucky. It was a gm of missed opportunities as MU had 25-12 FD, 445-280 yd and 38:38-21:22 TOP edges but 6 TO's did them in. QB Hendrix is showing why he rode the bench at ND as he is only comp 48.5% of his passes. While you have to wonder where UM's mindset will be here, Miami is just 2-11 ATS as an AD.

**OHIOST By 38 over Kent St** - OSU is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series winning 51-17 (-28) in '02 and 48-3 (-31) in '07. Interestingly, under Meyer in gms vs the MAC, the team that has st'd poorly has covered. In '12 Miami outplayed OSU in the 1Q but the Bucks came back to cover 56-10 (-25). LY OSU had a 314-125 yd edge in the 1H vs Buffalo and led the game 23-0 at 1 point but UB battled back to only lose 40-20 (+34). It is interesting to note that Kent St HC Haynes was the DB cch at OSU from 2005-'10 and later promoted to co-DC in '11 but that was under former HC Tressel. The Golden Flashes are 2-23-1 s/'88 in road openers incl 6 str losses by 28 ppg but have covered 3 of their L/4. Kent comes in at 0-2 SU/ATS after a 23-13 loss (+3) to S Alabama and after starting 11-1 (ranked #18) in 2012, they are now 4-12. The Bucks offense had a bad match-up LW vs a fast VT D and their inexp'd OL and QB were exposed in the 35-21 loss (-11) as QB JT Barrett was just 9-29-219-1-3 while getting sacked 7 times. It was their first loss in a home opener since 1978. However, with a bye on deck and off a loss, look for the Bucks to cruise.

**OLD DOMINION By 17 over Eastern Michigan** - First meeting. ODU comes in 1-1 SU/ATS after LW's 46-34 loss (+16) to NC State, a gm they led 21-10 at one pt. Offense has never been the problem as QB Heinicke is avg 278 ypg (72%) w/a 5-3 ratio and the ground gm has been effective avg 192 (5.3) TY. The "No D U" moniker was put on them LY and the jury is still out TY after 2 gms all'g 37 ppg and 456 ypg. EM is 1-1 SU/0-2 ATS after suffering a 65-0 (+39) beat down at the hands of Florida LW. The Eagles were outFD'd 27-7, outgained 655-125 and had 5 TO's. They have just 144 pass yds combined in the 1st 2 wks, which makes us wonder if they are even capable of getting a back-door vs a ODU tm that has been notorious for all'g it vs lesser competition recently.

**VIRGINIA TECH by 13 over East Carolina** - Naturally VT has controlled this series going 10-1 SU, however EC is on a 4-1-1 ATS run. LY VT had a 311-204 yd edge but missed 2 FGs, was SOD at the EC 10 and int'd at the EC32. At the end of the game, the ball was knocked out of Carden's hands into the EZ. If VT fell on it they would have covered, but EC fell on it for a safety so VT won 15-10 (-7). EC has hosted the last 2 and their LTH in '10, they led 27-21 in the 3Q but VT won 49-27 (-20), their lone cover in the last 6 years. LW the Hokies notched their biggest win in yrs as they upset #8 Ohio St 35-21 (+11) thanks to an aggressive D that piled up 7 sks and forced 3 TO's. While he did throw 2 int's, TT trans QB Michael Brewer has given the VT offense a more consistent look TY. The Pirates did put forth a respectable gm in their 33-23 loss (+15) to S Car LW as they had 27-26 FD and 453-441 yd edges. QB Carden was 32 of 46 for 321 yds but did have a couple of costly int's. EC is 3-8 ATS as an AD and while it is notable that they are 7-0 SU/ATS after a loss the L2Y, they are in a tough SC, VT, NC stretch and we think the Hokies are in prime position to make some noise TY.

**Pittsburgh by 28 over FIU** - In the only prior gm ('10) Pitt won 44-17 (-17) outgaining FIU 469-316 (FD's even). The gm was 10-10 until a Pitt fg as time exp'd before HT. Pitt led 23-17 early 4Q but scored 21 unanswered in the L/9:43. Pitt so far TY looks like a tm to be reckoned within the ACC at 2-0 SU/ATS as they have dominated their opp at the LOS with a combined 712-168 rush yd edge led by RB James Conner who has 367 rush yds (7.3). LW FIU notched a 34-3 (-11) win over Wagner. St'g true frosh QB Alex McGough hit 9-18-60 but LY's starter EJ Hilliard showed his worth hitting 14-15-169. This will be a big step up though as they have played 2 FCS tms to open. This could be Pitt's largest away fall role since at least 2001 (42-0 -21 to Rutgers) and they do have a big gm vs Iowa on deck, but we feel that this Pitt tm could be one of the best they've had in at least 5 yrs.

**Boise St by 21 over CONNECTICUT** - First meeting. LW we cashed a 2★ on these pages and our Top Weekly LPS on the Broncos in their 37-24 (-9) win over Colorado St. We felt the previous wks results were very misleading and Boise was laying single digits at home for only the 2nd time in the L/9 yrs vs a conf opp. The gm wasn't as close as the final indicated as they led 37-10 after 3Q, had 35-23 FD edges and piled up 676 yds (5th most in schl history). They also dominated the LOS as after CSt had 2 RB's top 100 rush yds vs Colorado in the opener, Boise held them to just 28 yds while Bronco RB Jay Ajayi had 219 rush (6.6). UConn is 0-2 ATS TY after escaping Stony Brook 19-16 (-13) LW. QB Casey Cochran DNP (CS) and Chandler Whitmer was 12-27-142-1-0. Conn is 19-5 ATS as a HD but lost in that role TY to BYU 35-10 (+14). While Boise's lines at home have been inflated in recent yrs, they are 22-9 ATS as an AF and look for them to roll here despite the rare trip to the East Coast (furthest trip s/o's).

**GEORGIA TECH by 17 over Georgia Southern** - Option vs option. These instate universities are 209 miles apart, but this is their 1st meeting. GT HC Paul Johnson helped build this program as he was the DL cch '83-'84, the OC '85-'86 and ret'd as the HC from '97-'01 with a 36-4 record and B2B IAA Nat'l Championships. Both tms come in at 2-0 as GT spoiled Tulane's home stadium debut scoring the final 24 pts in a 38-21 win (-10) LW. They already beat another option schl TY in Wofford 38-19 (-29) but were outruled 271-226 and only led 24-19 mid-4Q. Georgia Southern, meanwhile, destroyed FCS cellar dweller Savannah St 83-9 (-42) LW as they piled up 599 rush yds. They shouldn't be overwhelmed playing a Power 5 conf foe here as they notably upset Florida 26-20 (+28) LY and nearly beat NC St TY (lost 24-23, +20).

**IOWA By 10 over Iowa St** - Iowa is 7-3 SU the last 10 years but just 4-6 ATS as ISt pulled upsets in '11 (+6) home and '12 (+3) away. In the L6Y IU forced 20 TO's and ISt only had 7 (Iowa +13). LY we had a 3★ College Totals winner on the Under and IU dominated more than the final score indicated. IU had a 186-63 yd edge at half and led 13-0. IU pulled ahead 27-7 with just 7:05 left in the game. ISU went 82/7 for a td w/4:27 left and then went 56/9 for a td w/2:26 left to only lose 27-21 (+1). IU had a 218-59 rush edge and the team that's had more yds rushing has won 8 in a row. Iowa has now been favored 14 str yrs in this series but have not looked that impressive so far TY as they are 0-2 ATS and have only beaten N Iowa and Ball St by a comb 12 pts despite being a 2 td-plus fav in both. LW they had to score 2 td's in the final 3 min to pull out a 17-13 win but did have 27-13 FD and 455-219 yd edges (missed 3 FG's). The Cyclones are 0-2 SU but LW showed a lot of grit following a 20 pt loss to FCS NDSt. After trailing 13-0, they scored 28 unanswered pts before succumbing 32-28 (+12) to Kansas St. On paper, Iowa is clearly the better team but look for ISt to play inspired for a 2nd wk in a row.

**VANDERBILT By 21 over Umass** - This is the 3rd meeting for these two. LTH VU only had 443-264 yd and 22-16 FD edges as UMass had 3 TO and was SOD at the VU9 and 28 yd lines in a 49-7 loss (+33). LY UMass hosted their first ever SEC team and appeared poised for the upset as it was 10-7 after 3Q and VU gained 167 of their 406 yds in the 4Q in a 24-7 win (-29). It has been a nightmare start to the Derek Mason era as the Dores are 0-2 SU/ATS and off B2B blowout losses to Temple and Ole Miss. LW they were destroyed 41-3 (+19) as they were offFD'd 34-9 and outgained 547-167. Mason is playing 25 true frosh and rFr and LW went to Stephen Rivers who played the whole gm despite being 6-25-60-0-1. After getting dominated in the opener, the Minutemen looked improved LW in a 41-38 (+18) loss as they actually led 31-20 in the 3Q. Tough to make Vandy too large of a fav in this one considering what we've seen so far but UMass is 4-10 ATS as an AD and playing their 3rd str Power 5 conf tm (with Penn St on deck).

**VIRGINIA By 1 over Louisville** - Home team has won both but the L/meeting was in '89. The Cards come in 2-0 SU/ATS and beat FCS Murray St LW 66-21 (-37). QB Gardner has been efficient so far TY comp 66% w/a 4-0 ratio and the UL D looks like it has not missed a beat. UVA is also off a blowout win over a FCS foe as they beat Richmond 45-13 (-17) snapping their 10-game losing streak. It should be noted that they did get outgained 422-330 as they benefitted from 7 Richmond TO's. QB Greyson Lambert surprisingly got the start (13-15-102-1-0) after struggling LW. Matt Johns who looked great in the opener was 4-7-65-1-1. The two tms are actually tight talent wise and we'll side with the home dog who is due for an upset.

**OREGON By 35 over Wyoming** - First meeting. The Cowboys are 1-11 SU in road openers incl being shutout 3x's but have covered each of their L/4. WY has dropped 20 str vs ranked foes (L/win in '02 vs #22 AF 34-26 +18) and are 6-12 ATS the L/8 yrs. LW while the Ducks did win and cover vs #7 Mich St (46-27 -13), keep in mind, they scored the gms final 28 pts and the yds were close (491-466). After 2 wks QB Mariota is your Heisman favorite after going 17-28-318-3-0 vs one of the better D's in the country. On the other side, the Cowboys are off to a 2-0 SU/ATS start under new HC Bohl but both gms have been ugly as they have beaten Montana and AF by a comb 34-25. They are 17-6 ATS as an AD but that was under former HC Christensen. Clearly the Ducks have all the edges, but will there be a hangover from LW's marquee gm?

**Air Force By 17 over GEORGIA ST** - First meeting. Into '14, AF is 1-11 SU/3-9 ATS on the road the L3Y w/an avg loss by 16 ppg (win by 1 pt at WY). This will be AF's first trip to GA since '79 and while they won't have to deal with the heat and humidity of the South, they will be playing in a dome for the first time in schl history. There is also some firsts for Ga St as it's the first non-conf FBS team that they've hosted and also the 1st option based tm they have played in schl history. LY against run-heavy Chattanooga (non-option), the Panthers allowed a ssn worst 401 yds rushing and 6.7 ypc. LW we cashed a couple of FREE comp plays (Call 347-677-1700 every day during FB ssn) in gms involving these tms as New Mexico St won outright over Georgia St as our Underdog POW (given out FREE on Button #3 every Tuesday) and AF/Wyoming easily went UNDER the Total for our NC Sport Comp Totals POW (given out FREE on Button #9 every Saturday). Both tms gave up td passes in the final seconds LW as they both could easily be 2-0 coming into this gm after going a combined 2-22 LY. However, in a gm of a lot of firsts, we'll side with the visitors as seeing the option for the 1st time could be a shock to the Ga St players.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE By 4 over Western Kentucky** - Home tm is 1-6 SU s/o '91. In the L/meeting ('12) MT won 34-29 (+8). MT never trailed but the gm was tied 3x's. At 27-27 w/6:17 left MT got a 96 yd KO ret td and then sealed the win w/a int at their 6 (on 1D) w/1:39 left. LTH ('11) WKU ret'd a KO 90 yds to break a 16-16 tie but all'd a 86/15pl td drive. WKU had a 46 yd fg blk'd as time exp'd but won it in 2OT on a 7 yd td run after MT settled for a 23 yd fg. Both tms come in at 1-1 as after blowout wins in their openers, they had respectable losses on the road to Big Ten teams LW. MT found themselves down 28-0 at HT but rallied back in the 2H to lose 35-24 (+16) to Minnesota. They did get a backdoor cover TD w/:45 left but overall had 23-18 FD and 445-351 yd edges. WKU got a

lot of smoke blown their way after destroying BG in their opener but LW blew a 27-21 4Q lead in a 42-34 loss (+4) to Illinois. Toss-up type of game and we'll take the home team.

**DUKE By 10 over Kansas** - Duke lost 44-16 (+23) in '09 (only prior gm). Blue Devils led 7-0 mid-1Q but all'd 27 unanswered and could get no closer than 17 pts in the 2H. KU is 3-14 SU in road openers and has dropped 24 str AG's (last W at UTEP in '09's opener). They have gone 7-17 ATS in the losing streak. LW Kansas survived a late SE Missouri St rally in their 34-28 win (-25). The Jayhawks actually led 24-0 after 1Q and took that lead into the 2H. It was 34-7 after 3Q before SEMO scored 3 td's. Duke is 2-0 in B2B seasons for the first time since 1987-88 but LW were a huge road fav (-19) at Troy and found themselves down 14-3 early before eventually winning 34-17. They have now won 8 str non-conf gms, matching the program's best streak set in 1931-33. Kansas HC Weis sees the Duke gm as a 'great opportunity' to end KU's road losing skid and while they won't get the SU win, we think they are capable of keeping it reasonable.

**Georgia by 10 over SOUTH CAROLINA** - SC had won 3 in a row in this series until LY's loss. UGA was at home LY and despite being #11, was favored over #6 SC and won 41-30 (-3). The key play of the game with UGA clinging to a 34-30 lead, on 3&13, they got an 85 yd td pass to go up 41-30. Spurrier said "It was a tail kicking. Give UGA credit, the ran it right down our throat." The LTH SC absolutely dominated UGA leading 35-0 before allowing a late td. TY UGA is fresh off a bye after their 45-21 win (-7) over Clemson where they didn't allow a FD in the 2H and held the Tigers to just 15 total yds. RB Todd Gurley was a man amongst Boys as he ran for 198 yds and added a 100-yd KR td. Also don't discount their depth as they have Marshall and true frosh Michel and Chubb that can wear down opp early and then UGA can use Gurley more in the 2H facing tired legs. SC rebounded after their A&M beatdown to beat EC LW 33-23 (-15). However, they were outgained 453-441 and are all'g 567 ypg on D. Not good news facing a UGA tm that could be smelling blood in the water.

**Arkansas By 1 over TEXAS TECH** - UA is 28-7 vs TT but has dropped B2B meetings. LTH ('91) in their LY playing in the SWC the Razorbacks lost 38-21 (+4). In the L10Y this is only the 4th gm at a non-conf foe (0-3: lost in '05 vs #1 USC, '08 vs #7 Texas and LY vs Rutgers). The last time that the Red Raiders hosted an SEC school was '02 when they beat Ole Miss 42-28 (-3) as Kingsbury was the st'g QB. While TT is 2-0 SU, they have only won their 2 gms by a combined 11 pts despite being a 29 and 21 pt fav. LW they rallied to beat UTEP 30-26 on the road. The schl rec 10-gm losing streak is officially over for the Hogs as they raced out to a 56-0 HT lead and won 73-7 (-41) over Nicholls St. QB Allen only completed 4 passes but all were td's and both RB's Williams and Collins topped 100 yds. We always think FB gms are won at the LOS and the Hogs Top 10 OL unit in the country will be taking on a TT DL that is all'g 228 rush ypg (4.3) to the likes of C Ark and UTEP in the 1st 2 gms.

**MIAMI FL by 14 over Arkansas St** - The only prior meeting between these tms was in '97 as the Hurricanes won 42-10 (-41). UM rebounded from their poor showing vs LVille with a 'feel good' 41-7 (-46) win over FCS Fla A&M. UM had sizeable 21-5 FD and 416-114 yd edges but did turn the ball over 3X. This will be the 2nd str away gm for ASt as they kept it respectable in the loss against Tennessee LW 34-19 (+16) getting outFD'd 23-17 and outgained 415-331. ASU is 3-6 SU/4-5 ATS in the 2nd gm of B2B road gms and the last time Miami dropped a HG vs a non-conf foe was in '11 (lost 28-24 vs KSt). Since then they have won 7 str (3-4 ATS) by an avg score of 42-9. Ark St's players don't get fazed by much these days and certainly the 30% full Sun Life Stadium won't be intimidating after playing in front of 100,000 LW.

**Miss St by 20 over S ALABAMA** - First ever Power-5 conf team to visit Mobile and you can expect to hear a fair share of cowbells as Miss St sold out of its allotted tickets. After a ssn opening dominating win over SM, MSU survived a much tougher than expected contest with UAB as they were nearly a 4 td fav and won 47-34, getting outgained 548-516 incl allowing 435 pass yds. USA traveled to Kent St LW and won 23-13 (-3) with 20-15 FD & 347-277 yd edges while only allowing 64 rush yds (2.3). Since moving up to the FBS in '12, USA has yet to win a home opener (also 0-2 ATS) despite playing upstart UTSA in '12 and FCS Southern Utah LY. These 2 tms have met prior in '12 as it was USA's first gm vs a ranked opp (#23). While the Jags lost 30-10 (+34) they had a 21-15 FD edge and were only outgained 356-247 (-2 TO's). While we were thinking of fading Miss St here originally, LW's close call means the Jags will have their full attention despite a gm vs LSU on deck.

**MISSISSIPPI by 24 over Louisiana** - While an SEC HC would never circle a game vs a Sun Belt foe Hugh Freeze did lose to Hudspeth and UL 30-21 in 2011 when the teams were a combined 11-1! At 2-0 incl a nationally televised game and a conf road game under their belt the Reb's are in a prime spot also having a bye on deck. They are coming off a 41-3 (-19) road win at Vandy that could have been even more lopsided than the final score indicated as Rebels had 34-9 FD and 547-167 yd edges. This is UM's home opener and they are 4-1 ATS under Freeze as a non-conf HF. We cashed an easy 4★ LPS release and a 2★ on these pages LW going against UL as they were a DD fav to LT and lost 48-20 (-15'). This is UL's road opener where they are 1-5 SU/2-4 ATS. It doesn't get any easier for UL as they have another road trip on deck with a trip to the Blue Turf (Boise) waiting in the wings. Look for the Rebs to cruise for a 3rd str week.

**WASHINGTON by 17 over Illinois** - LY these tms pl'd in Chicago and UW QB Price hit 28-35-342 and Bishop Sankey ran for 208. UW had a 615-327 yd edge but IU got within 7 in the 4Q despite trailing 31-10 at one point. IU got a td with 9:10 left to pull within 31-24, down 34-24 they were int'd at the UW31 w/3:55 left. Entering the ssn it was presumed that both of these tms would be unbeaten heading into this B10/P12 matchup and that has pl'd true. UW has squeaked by in its first 2 gms despite being a DD fav in both. After going up 21-0 1Q LW against EW, the Huskies found themselves down 38-37 3Q and 45-44 4Q before scoring two 4Q td's to win 59-52 (-13). UW was actually offFD'd 35-26 and outgained 573-536 by their FCS foe. IU meanwhile had trouble with YSU in their opener and was down 27-21 4Q LW against WKU before scoring three 4Q td's to pull out a 42-34 (-4') win. The Illini did have the FD (28-23) and yd (520-400) edges. IU has lost 11 of 12 neutral/road openers (4-8 ATS) with the avg loss by 17 ppg and UW is 5-2 ATS as a non-conf HF. Huskies finally get a comfortable win.

**ALABAMA by 45 over Southern Miss** - In the past 3 years when Bama has faced a non-Power 5 team prior to an SEC foe they won 31-6, 35-0 and 41-0. The problem for Tide backers is that they were 0-3 ATS in those games laying 39, 38 and 47 pts! After a tougher than expected opener vs WV, Bama cruised to a lightning shortened 41-0 (-40') shutout over FAU. WR Cooper tied the schl rec with 13 catches and his 4 consec 100 yd rec gms is the longest such streak under HC Saban at Bama. After building a 23-7 4Q lead against Alcorn St LW, SM held on for a 26-20 (-18) win as the yds were nearly even (415-393) but the Eagles were +4 TO's. UA has won 5 str in this series but they haven't faced one another s/o's. Since losing to ULM in '07 (Saban's 1st yr here) Bama is a perfect 19-0 SU but just 9-10 ATS hosting non-conf foes all'g 7 pts or less 17 times incl 7 shutouts. Look for the Tide to Roll here but there is too many pts for our liking.

**UTAH St by 21 over Wake Forest** - First meeting. Not quite sure that Utah St got out all their frustrations vs Idaho St after that stinker vs Tennessee but one thing that has normally held true is to play the favorite in an Aggies game (now 17-4 ATS). QB Keeton has struggled throwing the ball after his return from an ACL inj suffered LY but he should be getting better as the ssn rolls along. Wake showed at ULM that with a frosh QB their offense is suspect, although they did look more efficient LW gaining 387 yds albeit against lowly Gardner-Webb. After that opening ssn loss, the Demon Deacons fell to 2-6 ATS s/'09 in non-conf AG's, while UTSt is on a 4-1 ATS run in non-conf HG's. Aggies win easily.

## TEXAS ST +12' over NAVY

You might not find a larger scheduling edge this week. Texas St is off a 65-0 win (-27') over Ark Pine-Bluff and had a bye last week (extra time to prep for option) while Navy is playing away from home for the 3rd str gm. The Bobcats also played well in their 2012 trip to Navy covering as a 13' pt dog (21-10). The Navy rush off has been sensational so far this ssn as after rushing for 370 (5.9) vs the best DL in the country (OSU), they had 487 (7.7) vs Temple in their 31-24 win (-3) as they avg'd 7.3 ypp. However, we can't back the Middies here in their largest AF role s/07 and they are on just a 4-8 ATS run as an AF incl outright losses to WKU LY (19-7, -3'), at Troy in '12 (41-31, -1') and at San Jose ST in '11 (27-24, -6'). The clincher is the fact TX St pulled a couple of upsets as a HD LY.

**Tulsa By 4 over FAU** - This is the 1st meeting and this is FAU's home opener where they are 1-2 SU/0-3 ATS since opening their stadium in '11. This is UT's road opener, where they are just 2-17 SU/4-14-1 ATS incl dropping 4 str SU/ATS by 19 ppg. Now that the Owls have filled their coffers after money games at Nebraska and Bama, it's time to focus on winning games. The problem is, they looked like they have taken a step back TY under new HC Charlie Patridge as they used to cash those money gms (11-2 ATS as AD prior to TY). Their gm against Bama LW was called early due to lightning but there was just under 8 min left (need to play 55 min to make it count in Vegas). Tulsa is off Oklahoma, but the difference is they were fired up hosting their in-state big brother with a definite letdown after losing 52-7 (+24'). They were held to 9 rush yds in the 1H and turned the ball over a total of 4 times incl a couple of 14 pt swings. While the situation favors FAU here, we do like what we have seen from the Tulsa offense (minus the TO's of course) as they are avg 460 ypg.

**OKLAHOMA ST By 10 over Utsa** - In the 1st ever meeting LY OSU travelled to UTSA and was -27. OSU st'd JW Walsh and took him out with 6:00 left in the 3Q and OSU up 42-7. UTSA got under the number, but OSU got a td w/5:27 left to lead 56-28. UTSA then on 4&6 got a 15 yd td pass with 1:14 left for the backdoor cover. After the teams inaugural season in 2011 all UTSA has done is go 9-4 SU on the road and 10-3 ATS. Don't mind fading the country's least experienced team versus the most experienced unit in the country who held Arizona to 19 pts after a first play 85 yd TD and who also held the Wildcats who have a similar offense to Okl St to 4-16 on 3rd & 4th down conv's as we cashed a Thurs night Marquee winner on the UNDER. Certainly respect the Cowboys and their 22-10 ATS record as a HF but they are overvalued after keeping it close vs Florida St and beating Missouri St.

**LSU By 31 over Ulim** - Battle of Louisiana. Just kidding. The only 2 previous meetings were in '03 and '10 with LSU winning 49-7 (-34') and 51-0 (-33). Sam Houston St entered their matchup with LSU LW avg 614 ypg and 43 ppg their F/2 gms. The Tigers held them to just 206 yds in the 56-0 (-33) shutout. So far this short ssn, LSU has had to deal with adversity in wk 1 (down 24-7 to Wisc), and not looking past an inferior opponent wk 2, and have passed both tests. They will get a ULM squad that has fared well against SEC tms in recent history as they wr'd 2 in '12 beating Arkansas 34-31 (+30') and losing to Auburn 31-28 (+15) both going to OT. The Warhawks are 2-0 but LW had to score a td w/09 left to escape vs Idaho 38-31 (-14). They do have a bye on deck while LSU has a conf gm vs Miss St. Look for NLU to keep it reasonable as LSU is 5-10 ATS as a DD fav.

**Notre Dame By 24 over Purdue** - Lucas Oil Stadium, Indianapolis, IN. From '97-'07 PU was 5-6 SU and 6-5 ATS in this series but s/PU's 33-19 non-covering win in '07 (-21') ND has now won 6 in a row SU/3-3 ATS. L2Y a weak PU team has taken the Irish to the wire each yr. LY ND was in a flat spot off of Mich with Mich St, Ariz St and Okla on deck. In '12 they were off their trip to Ireland. LY PU took their opening drive 75/12pl for a td and got a 47 yd fg 10-0. With 5:58 left 1H PU had a 147-43 yd edge. ND tied it at the start of the 4Q then got an 82 yd td pass to Daniels 2:07 later, then 1:12 later a 34 yd IR td and in 1:22 the Irish had 2 td's on zero FD and took a 31-17 lead and would go on to win 31-24 (-18'). ND is once again off Mich with a bye on deck while PU is off CM with only S III on deck making this an "A" game for them. However, they are reeling after a 38-17 loss (-3') to the Chips while the Irish put an exclamation point to end the Michigan series w/a 31-0 win (-3') becoming the 1st tm to shut out UM s/84 (NCAA rec 365 gms). ND is clearly a different tm with Golson as the str as he has never lost a reg ssn gm (12-0 SU/8-3-1 ATS) and has 8 total td's and 0 TO's TY. The Irish are a perfect 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in these Shamrock Series games (+23 ppg) and look for them to coast here. However, this line will be inflated due to LW's results and PU always finds a way to play the Irish tough.

**FLORIDA by 24 over Kentucky** - The Gators simply own the Wildcats. UF has won 27 in a row over UK SU and 7 in a row ATS and have outgained the Cats by 207 ypg the last 6. In the last 3 games here in The Swamp UF has won by an avg of 50-6 with the avg line of 17. The L5 meetings UF has led by a comb 104-10 after 1Q. LTH UK was shutout 38-0 and their deepest drive got to the UF29. The 27 gm series active win streak is the 2nd longest behind PSU over Temple (30 wins). This is the conf opener for both tms as UF snapped their 7 gm losing streak in style LW with a 65-0 (-39') shutout over EM. They appeared to take their frustrations out after their opener was susp'd as they had 27-7 FD and 655-125 yd edges UK does appear improved under HC Stoops as the last time they st'd the ssn 2-0 SU/ATS was in '10. We used the Cats as a 4★ on these pages LW as well as a 4★ LPS winner and they could have beaten Ohio worse than the 20-3 final (-13). No way will we step in front of a streak here.

**OKLAHOMA By 24 over Tennessee** - This is the 1st ever meeting in a reg ssn gm and only the 3rd meeting overall (1st s/68 Orange Bowl). OU is 6-2 ATS in their reg ssn non-conf marquee matchups against Power 5 conf tms and is 5-2 ATS at home vs non-conf tms. OU looks poised to be a part of the 4 tm playoff as they've handled their undermatched foes with ease by a combined 100-23! UT has dropped 7 str 'true' road openers by 13 ypg (3-4 ATS) incl LY in HC Jones' 1st yr when they traveled to Oregon and got pouted by 45 pts (+28). The Sooners D is usually not the unit to receive praise, but TY so far they have held LaTech & Tulsa to 573 yds. Those 2 tms had 1,125 yds in their other 2 gms! While Tenn looked much improved TY off to a 2-0 start, look for the Sooners to make a statement especially considering HC Stoops "SEC Comments" as of late.

**UTEP By 13 over New Mexico St** - The Miners are going for a 6th str I-10 rivalry win (4-0-1 ATS). LY in Kugler's 1st win as HC, NMSt answered each of UTEP's first 3 td's (21-21 w/7:27 3Q). From there UTEP scored 21 unanswered holding NMSt to 72 yds. The LTH UTEP (-13) led 27-7 at the half and 41-14 in the 4Q but NMSt went 82/9 and 89/12 for a pair of garbage td drives to give them the backdoor push. This visitor in this rivalry is 7-2 ATS. UTEP nearly pulled out the outright upset over heavily favored TT LW as they led 26-23 4Q before giving up a late 75/7 td drive w/2:32 left. While they were outgained 504-393, they did hold the FD edge 23-19. NMSt found themselves down 24-10 3Q at Ga St LW before mounting a comeback and scoring the GW td w/15 left. They were outgained 456-435 but did hold the FD edge 26-23. Big sked edge to the Minors who have a bye on deck while the Aggies have another rivalry gm hosting NM. Look for some pts in this one, but in the end the Miners nab their 7th straight win in the rivalry.

**Ucla by 6 over Texas** - Arlington, TX at Dallas Cowboys Stadium. While UCLA has won 3 of the past 4 matchups s/97, UT did win 49-20 (-3') in the last meeting ('11). UT was dominated by a physical BYU tm LW 41-7 (+1). They were outFD'd 28-15 and outgained 429-258 as new starting QB Swoopes threw for just 176 yds (1-1 ratio). UT is just 3-7-1 ATS against ranked foes on a neutral field. UCLA HC Mora had been 7-1 ATS in non-conf gms before this ssn. UCLA, surprisingly struggled for the 2nd str wk, this time at home to Memphis as the 2 tms were tied at 35 in the 4Q. The Bruins did have 30-24

FD and 540-469 yd edges. Both tms have byes on deck and while both had physical matchups LW, a case can be made that UCLA was peeking ahead a bit at this matchup while the same cannot be said for Texas, who was playing with clear revenge, but were embarrassed for a 2nd str yr.

**RUTGERS By 1 over Penn St** - This is actually the 25th all-time meeting between these new conf foes (PSU 22-2 SU), but they haven't met s/95 and haven't pl'd in NJ s/55. PSU is off a 21-3 win (-14) over Akron where they had 27-17 FD and 425-277 yd edges but both tms blew multiple chances to score in the RZ. The Nittany Lions have been a Conf AF just twice the L2Y and is 1-1 SU/ATS. They are also just 1-9 ATS in conf openers. RU is off a 38-25 win (-36') over Howard but were outFD'd 21-20 and outgained 437-397. They did have a sizeable 31-7 HT lead and were never really challenged. This will be the 1st time the Scarlet Knights find themselves as a HD s/11. Rutgers new OC Ralph Friedgen was the HC when James Franklin was the heir apparent at Maryland. Franklin said Friedgen had a huge impact on him (asst for 7 yrs) while the Fridge says "Not that much, no" about their current relationship. Coach Flood is fired up "make sure you get a good seat" after Franklin's comments about recruiting in the area and how Penn St will dominate it. Look for this to go down to the wire.

**Usc by 17 over BOSTON COLLEGE** - USC is 4-0 SU in this series incl a 34-7 win the last/only time here ('88). These tms met LY in Cali as BC trailed 28-0 w/13:23 left being outgained at that point 370-168. Seven of their first 8 drives ended in punts (other was SOD). USC is coming off a physical 13-10 win (+3) at Stanford in a gm in which they were outFD'd 21-16 and outgained 413-291. The Trojans forced 2 TO's and K Andre Heidari's career long 53 yd fg w/2:30 left proved to be the game winner. RB Buck Allen's 154 rush yds were the 2nd most ever by a RB against a David Shaw ch'd SU tm. After pulling the upset over SU LY, USC responded with an 18 pt win at Colo but failed to cover (-21). BC meanwhile is off a home loss to Pitt 30-20 (-4') on Fri when they were outFD'd 22-15 and outgained 414-276. The Eagles all'd Pitt RB James Conner to rush for a career high 214 yds, which was the most yds an opposing player has rushed for in the L10Y. After a respectable outing in his 1st start as BC's QB, Tyler Murphy went a disastrous 10-28-134-1-2 against Pitt. While the situation edge clearly favors BC here, we think the Trojans are a legit Top 10 team and could be 10-0 heading into late November.

**TEXAS A&M By 31 over Rice** - These former SWC foes (1920-1995) met LY, which was their only recent meeting as Manziel was susp'd for the 1H and Rice actually led 28-21 with a 332-315 yd edge at HT. With Manziel under center in the 2H, A&M pulled away for a 52-31 (-28) win. RU hasn't won in College Station s/80 dropping 8 str trips incl LY and haven't beaten a ranked tm s/97 (0-23 SU/9-14 ATS). Rice did have extra time to prepare after their ssn opening loss to ND as they had a bye LW and have their home opener against Old Dominion next week. No 'Johnny Football' no prob for the Aggies as new starting QB Kenny Hill followed up his 3 TD performance in his 1st car start vs SC with 4 TD's LW vs Lamar in a little over 2Q's and now has a perfect 7-0 ratio on the ssn. Aggies should easily get their 3rd straight win.

**N Illinois by 10 over UNLV** - These 2 tms haven't met s/95 and NIU is 3-0 SU overall vs UNLV. After upsetting B10 foe NW on the road LW 23-15 (+6'), the Huskies have now won 25 reg ssn gms in a row SU (18-7 ATS). They were able to limit NW to just 72 rush yds. They do have a tough trip to SEC country (Ark) next week, so the sked is unkind. While NIU is in the 2nd of 3 straight away they've gone 9-2 ATS as an AF although both losses were versus non-conf/non-P5 foes. UNLV survived 4 TO's to escape with a win over FCS N Colo 13-12 (-28). They barely had the yardage edge 332-327 while the FD's were even at 19 a piece. The Rebels are avg 165 rush ypg while the Huskies are allowing just 69 rush ypg. UNLV is now 12-5-1 ATS as a HD but did go 2-2 LY as teams took them more seriously.

**Arizona St by 10 over COLORADO** - AST is now a perfect 5-0 SU/5-0 ATS in this series despite favored by an avg of 22 pts and they are +224 ypg. Their last trip here AST only led 20-17 at half but had a 320-84 yd edge in the 2H, 51-17 on a Thurs night game. LY AST had a 407-76 yd edge at half and led 47-6. Conf opener for both teams. CU HC MacIntyre said LY's meeting was their worst gm of the year. CU returns home after a rare road win (only 3rd in 7Y) so not covering a 18' pt spread at UMass is understandable especially considering they were off their rival and were making one of the longest road trips in schl history. CU did hold the FD edge 29-23 and the yds edge 474-371, but were down by 11 in the 3Q before mounting a comeback. CU is just 3-8 ATS as a home dog in conf action since joining the P12 in '11. AST did cover LW on the road at NM (-23') as they had 25-20 FD and 621-337 yd edges incl a an incredible 423 rush yds (8.8!), their most s/96. They outscored NM 26-2 in the 2H. While series says take the Sun Devils, they could get caught peeking ahead to UCLA and USC on deck.

**Nebraska by 10 over FRESNO ST** - The only prior meeting was in Lincoln in '11. FSU lost 42-29 (+28'). FSU went 76/4pl for a td (2ptng) and trailed 28-26 w/12:06 left but #10 NU ret the ensuing KO 100 yds and after a FSU td put the gm away w/4 42 yd td run. While playing at USC and Utah in B2B wks is a challenge, the Red Wave is certainly not accustomed to their tm being outgained by nearly 600 yds in the 2 blowout losses. While this home opener is certainly circled, NU as well as the entire B10 feel the country's disrespect after needing a highlight reel TD by AA RB Abdullah in the closing seconds to escape McNeese ST LW. This will be the first time as an HD in DeRuyter's 3rd yr, but the previous 2Y they were led by the now Oakland Raiders starting QB Carr. NU's 3rd trip out west under Pelini as they lost to UCLA in '12, but won and covered at Wash and Wyoming previously and their fans will travel.

**ARIZONA by 14 over Nevada** - L/gm ("12 NM Bowl) AZ trailed 48-35 w/1:48 left and went 75/7pl to get within 6 and rec an inside kick w/4:00. Three plays later AZ got the GW td (only lead of gm) and int'd NV at the NV 46 to seal the win in HOF HC Chris Ault's disappointing last gm. The last time these 2 tms met in AZ was 1941! The Wildcats return home after getting a scare in San Antonio LW against UTSA. We did cash a Thurs Marquee winner on the UNDER. AZ used a balanced attack rushing for 223 yds and passing for 231 yds, but was outFD'd 23-22. NV meanwhile travels for the 1st time TY and is coming off a mild upset LW against another P12 foe in Wash St, despite being outFD'd 25-17 and outgained 427-324. It should be noted that they did lead throughout and won by DD's 24-13 (+3'). We feel both of these tms are play-on tms TY and we'll call for the HT near the line.

### KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Seattle by 13 over SAN DIEGO** - It's rare when the NFL has this type of schedule edge with SEA off their Thursday Night win while SD played a Monday Nite road game. Now the best team in the NFL is still laying a relatively short number and backers continue to cash as the Seahawks have covered 15 of 21 regular season games. LY SD QB Rivers was sacked 3 or more times in 3 games and they failed to cover all 3 while SEA had 3 or more sacks 8 times LY and also LW vs GB. The Chargers are 3-4 as a HD the L2Y but 2 of those wins were in their first 2 home games LY when they were a dog to HOU (2-14) and DAL (8-8). SEA is actually 8-2 ATS on the road and are more than physical enough defensively to take advantage of an avg OL on a short week to force mistakes here.

**3★ New England by 12 over MINNESOTA** - This is the Vikings 1st game at Gopher Stadium and they get the pleasure of hosting the Patriots of a loss (25-9 ATS). While NE faltered for us on this page LW both Brady and Belichick are embarrassed over the loss to MIA being held to 0 pts, 5 FD and 67 yds in 2H. The Vikings manhandled a Bradford-less Rams squad but not only got to face his replacement but then Hill (8-13-81) was banged up right before the half and Austin Davis (16-23-192) took his first ever snaps and played the 2H. The Vikings surprised St Louis by using Cordell Patterson on sweeps and he had 102 yds on 3 carries. 14 of MIN's pts were in the 4th Qtr with a drive helped by a roughing the punter penalty for a td and a pick-six. The value here is with the road team with LW's results serving only to spark Belichick's fire.

### OTHER SELECTION

**2★ Miami by 7 over BUFFALO** - These two have battled to stay out of the AFC East cellar for years and after both pulled upsets LW it's an early battle for 1st place. Have to favor the Dolphins who behind new OC Bill Lazor (Philly's QB coach LY) and new RB Moreno (134, 5.6) totaled 25 FD's and converted 7 of 13 of 3rd downs. Also have to give credit to the Fins defense which shut out the NE offense in the 2H after their HT adjustment holding Brady to 67 yds passing (10-27 in 2H). Miami's dynamic pass rush duo of Vernon & Wake picked up right where they left off (comb 20 sks LY) getting 3 sks and 4 QBH. BUF had 13 pts come off 3 TO's and only had 2 drives over 40 yds all day. They now get a MIA team that has faced BUF's systems before that held NE's RB's to 65 yds (3.8) LW. This is a revamped, retooled MIA team that gained a massive confidence boost LW vs a BUF team that isn't as good as LW's final score indicates.

### OTHER GAMES

**Pittsburgh at BALTIMORE - Thurs.** Nine of the L/10 games in the series have been decided by a FG with the Steelers covering 3 straight. Obvious early season pressure on the Ravens not to fall 2 back as they lost at home to CIN while PIT got past the Browns on the final play. It's crazy to ever think a week 2 game is a "must win" but if 0-2 in your division with both losses at home it'll be a heck of an uphill climb. Each and every Thursday we now have BOTH a College and NFL Marquee and if your going to watch you might as well win. If you are a 2014 Power Sweep Sub and use the code "7-pk special" you may purchase one Marquee 7-pack for only \$35 (that's \$5 per call)!

**CAROLINA by 3 over Detroit** - The Lions are off LW's Monday Nite game vs the Giants and those results are unavailable. CAR rallied behind QB Anderson LW (230 yds 71% 2-0) for the win LW as they took advantage of several key inj's beating TB. RB Martin (knee) left after 10 touches with LG Mankins (knee) also departing. They swamped a shocked TB OL and never gave McCown a chance to regain his bearing. CAR converted 3 TB TO's into 17 pts and wore down the TB def in the 1H with 22:45 to 7:15 TOP edge. They now face a solid DET OL that is used to facing elite DL in practice who have more outlets for Stafford to use to move the ball than TB. DET does have GB at home on deck so we'll call for the home team by a FG for now as we wait for the MNF results as we expect Newton to return.

**WASHINGTON by 13 over Jacksonville** - The NFL did the seemingly forever rebuilding Jaguars no favors by being 1 of 3 teams to start the season with B2B away games and scheduling PHI in the first with the D on the field for 82 plays. The Jags have to be crushed after leading 17-0 at HT and getting outscored 34-0 in the 2H. The reality is JAX's 2 TD "drives" were 44/4pl and 21/2pl and the "rush attack" avg'd 2.6 ypc while the unit was 2 of 14 on 3rd down. Griffin will welcome facing a bottom 5 defensive front 7 after facing HOU's top 5 unit that punished him with 3 sacks and an amazing 14 QBH. That pressure caused many short passes (7.2 ypa) but the run game which still totaled 131 yds (5.1) will allow the offense to open up this week. Starting in the 2Q for 4 straight series WAS had a punt blk'd for a TD, had the clock run out at HT due to penalties, they fumbled after 1 and goal at the HOU 7 and they fumbled at the HOU 91 JAX RB Gerhardt inj'd his ankle LW which is awful news to a team that may not have WR Shorts (hamstring) that started 3 rookie WR's. WAS rebounds here for Gruden's first win.

**TENNESSEE by 9 over Dallas** - You're 8-8 each of the L3Y and you get a marquee game as DAL to show the world this year is different. Instead your team with the same HC trails wire-to-wire as HOU gives SF 21 pts off 4 TO's and are beaten physically and mentally. Now on the flip side is a TEN team that went 6-10 and 7-9 the L2Y but changed coaches grabbing one of the leagues most respected coaches who took ARZ to a .500 season after 8 straight losing campaigns and then to the Super Bowl in his second season. By the way that same HC also beat your Cowboys team each of the 3 times he faced you pulling the outright upset in each. HC Whisenhunt also brought back his former DC Horton and the duo took over a ARZ D that was ranked #29 and finished #18, #12 and #6 his final 3Y. LW the Titans held KC to 245 yds and limited them to 1 of 12 on 3rd downs getting, 4 sks, 6 tfl's, 5 QBH and 3 int's. TEN improves to 2-0 and builds momentum under their new HC here.

**Arizona at NY GIANTS** - Both teams are off MNF so we don't know how the Cardinals defense held up or how the Giants new West Coast system fared. The Giants clearly have the situational edge being home on a short week with ARZ travelling to the East coast but the Cards went 6-2 ATS away LY failing to cover only at NO and SF. The Cardinals have a glaring hole in the middle of their defense due to injuries but we don't know the state of the Giants OL which did ok in preseason (135 yds 4.1 7 sks) but that was vs vanilla schemes. We'll pass on this for now as we simply don't have enough information to form an opinion.

**New Orleans by 6 over CLEVELAND** - Both teams in identical situations losing to division rivals on the by a FG on the final play. Have to believe the Saints were expecting a win LW while maybe only the Browns players expected to stay competitive. The Saints offense is clearly built for speed and turf and LY Brees had a 35-8 ratio with a 7.2 sack% on turf and a 4-4 ratio with a 12.9 sack% on grass. Another interesting fact is that the Saints are 0-5 in the second of B2B away games failing to cover by 12 ppg. The Browns and QB Hoyer were getting pummeled at the half (16-3 FD's & 364-101 yds) but he offense was quite different when RB West was featured (3 yds, 1.0 1stH) as he rushed for 97 yds (7.5) in the 2H putting together 5 straight drive of over 51 yds. NO did give up 568 yds to ATL LW but that was vs a top tier QB with plenty of speed at the WR spot. CLE may not have #1 RB Tate (knee) or #1 rec option TE Cameron (shoulder) though there is a chance Gordon (susp) may return it can't be banked on for a team off a tough loss.

**CINCINNATI by 7 over Atlanta** - ATL finished 0-7 SU & 1-6 ATS in opposing Stadiums LY and this is a bit of a letdown spot off an OT win vs NO win with TB on deck on Thursday. CIN got the season started with a confidence building road win but they sure did it the hard way getting inside the BAL 31 6 times and coming away with 15 pts on 5 FG's and one miss. CIN was a perfect 8-0 SU/ATS at home LY. Matt Ryan threw for 448 (72%) 3-0 in their opening win over NO with Julio Jones catching 116 (16.6). CIN's DB's got plenty of work as BAL threw the ball 62 times, but only all'd 56.5% comp with a 1-1 ratio. WR Bernard should have more running lanes TW as ATL all'd 5.0 ypc LW and CIN has their own star WR with AJ Green (131 yds 21.8 LW) setting up play action. We'll side with the home team in a better situation (TEN at home next) vs ATL off a big win now having to travel.

**TAMPA BAY by 1 over St Louis** - The Rams have covered 4 of the L5 vs TB including a 23-13 win over TB as a 3' pt HF. STL was forced to field 3rd string QB Austin Davis (192 yds 70% 0-1) LW after Hill (thigh) was KO'd LW. While the Rams rumbled off 318 yds they allowed 346 but did a great job shutting

If Hill can't go then Davis will have had all the reps in practice with the 1's and should show some improvement over a TB Def that all'd CAR backup QB Derek Anderson, who hadn't sid a gm in 4Y throw for 230 yds & 2 td's. The key here though is how TB's OL was mauled by the CAR DL LW and now face a STL defense that was embarrassed at home. We want to see the injury report here before making a final call as we go by the home team by a slim margin for now.

**Houston by 7 over OAKLAND** - This was to be Matt Schaub vs his former team but rookie David Carr changed those plans. OAK faced a tough D in the NY Jets and while Carr was TO free the Raiders were held to 158 yds, scoring on a 1Q 28 yd drive and a garbage TD with 1:21 left. In 7 straight drives from the 2Q-4Q Carr led them to 1 total FD. While HOU will be without #1 DC Clowney the Texans D led by DE Watt (1sk, 2 tfl, 5 QBH, 1 pd & 1 FR) had a mind numbing 14 QBH against a now veteran RGIll expect them to pin back their ears on this rookie. HOU won O'Brien's opener but the 17-6 final was deceiving as they were outgained 372-319. Fitzpatrick completed only 14 passes but his 9.4 ypa along Foster's 103 yds (3.8) was all the D needed. The culture has not changed in OAK hence their 5-11 ATS record at home and their only 3 SU wins at home came when they held the opp's rush D to 1.8, 1.9 and 1.8 ypc which won't happen vs the Foster led rush attack.

**GREEN BAY by 11 over the NY Jets** - On the surface this is a letdown spot for GB after opening the season at SEA with B2B road games at DET & CHI on deck. But, now off a loss we'll back the Packers. A quick look shows us GB was 3-4 as a HF LY and also 3-4 ATS off a loss. A more in-depth look shows that GB with Rodgers starting and finishing the game was 3-0 ATS LY as a HF and they've covered 14 of 18 while also going 14-4 ATS off a SU loss. Jets depth shy secondary had no issues vs a rookie QB Carr at home but they'll be exposed here in a polar opposite situation playing Aaron Rodgers on the road. Jets QB Smith has a 5-13 ratio on the road and he took 28 sacks in their F77 road games which spells trouble vs the Packers who have ranked #3 and #8 is sacks the L2Y. The Jets are improved offensively but the Packers have extra time to prep for Ryan's exotic schemes and won't have the home crowd edge to help mask their 11 pen/105 yds effort with an angry Lambeau crowd.

**DENVER by 16 over Kansas City** - DEN has controlled the AFC West going 12-4 ATS covering by an avg of 15 ppg with Manning avg 329 ypg (65%) with an 11-3 ratio vs the Chiefs the L2Y. The Chiefs who rode a #21 off and #24 D to the playoffs LY showed they are an avg team at best down the stretch LY as well as LW getting outgained 405-245 at home by TEN. When you backing this Bronco squad with Peyton under center you rarely if ever get back-door'd and in fact LY DEN outscored their opponents in the 2H by a combined 186-79! Already down ILB Mays (wrist) the Chiefs sustained a pair of huge losses with both ILB Derrick Johnson and DE DeVito lost for the year with Achilles inj's. Those are crippling inj's to a team like KC that isn't built for shootouts even with the return of WR Bowe. DEN's defense held RB Charles to 93 and 78 yds rushing LY and are better now which will make QB Smith's work harder and we'll take the home team by a beat up road team here.

**Chicago at San Francisco** - SNF - The Bears offense picked up right where they left off LY as they almost doubled the Bills FD's (29-15) but 3 TO's led to 13 BUF points. CHI battled back from a 17-7 HT deficit, scored with :30 left in regulation and won the toss but fell short. Now they are the 49ers first true opponent in new Levi Stadium. SF has covered 5 straight home openers but Cutler and crew have back door potential.

**Philadelphia at Indianapolis** - MNF - Last week in PHI the #2 offense of 2013 faced the #31 offense from LY and "as expected" it was 17-0 at the half. Reality set in and the Eagles scored 34 unanswered to not only win but cover. While Sun & Mon Nite home games were a norm with Manning here this only the Colts second since wk #3 in 2011 and the other was a win LY vs DEN. Remember on Monday Nights you can get a \$back+ guarantee. Call 347-677-1700 on game day for more details!
