## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ FLORIDA STATE over NC State** - This is homecoming weekend in Tallahassee. In this series FSU has gone 6-2 incl 2 str wins but NCSt is on an 8-1-1 ATS series run. LY #1 FSU just beat #22 CU in OT & trailed NCSt 24-21 at HT but eventually won 56-41 (-18) w/a 531-520 yd edge (-1 FD). LTH FSU won 49-17 (-32, led 42-0 at HT). The wk prior #5 FSU won at #3 CU 51-14 (one of the most hyped ACC mtg's of all-time). We cashed our 5★ College GOY (now 27-7, 79% all time) on FSU in their 23-13 (+10) loss on the road at CU LW! The 'Noles led for more than half the gm. FSU threw an int from the 20 when they were driving to take a 14 pt lead & were also SOD at the Tiger 40 w/6:13 left & the Tigers scored a td to take a 10 pt lead. The 'Noles never trailed ATS. NCSt has won 2 of 3 incl a 24-8 (-4) win on the road at BC LW. The Wolfpack were +66 yds & while they finished w/351 yds, that was the 3rd most BC has all'd all ssn. Vs 4 common foes (UL, WF, CU, BC) FSU is 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS, +8 ppq & -14 ypg. NCSt is 2-2 SU/ATS, +3 ppq & -13 ypg. NCSt is travelling for the 3rd time in 4W. FSU will be playing hard off a loss & has an FCS tm on deck. The 'Noles have a huge talent edge as well. **FORECAST: FLORIDA ST BY 21**

**3★ SAN DIEGO ST over Wyoming** - With different climates its surprising that the Visitor is 4-0 SU/3-0-1 ATS. In the L/gm ('12) SDSt won 42-28 (-7) after trailing 27-21 at HT. LTH ('11) WY stunned SDSt 30-27 (+18). Huge sked edge to SDSt as they are off a bye while WY is playing for a 11th str wk. Aztecs 2W ago easily won our top 4★ LPS play as well as our 4★ on these pages (3 Key winners L/4 gms) w/a 41-17 (-3) win at CSU. SDSt had a 456-368 yd edge (-1 FD). RB Pumphrey has run for over 100 yds in 6 of his L/7 gms incl 5 str. SDSt has won 5 str SU/ATS after opening 1-3 SU/0-4 ATS. WY has been a DD AD in all 5 prior road gms & are 4-1 ATS. WY is coming off a 26-7 loss to CSU (+9). WY was down 26-0 before they got their only td in the 4Q. WY was outgd 348-239. The Aztecs are 5-0 in conf play for the 1st time s/transiting to D1 in '69! SDSt is +104 ypg at home & +196 ypg in MW action. WY is -81 ypg on the road and -83 ypg in MW action. SDSt is fresh off a bye, is on a 5-0 ATS run & is 21-6 ATS vs conf foes incl 10-3 vs conf foes at home. **FORECAST: SAN DIEGO ST BY 35**

**3★ INDIANA (+) over Michigan** - This is IU's home finale and they are 0-6 SU/1-5 ATS in that role not involving Purdue (last win in '01 vs Kentucky). Not surprisingly, UM is 34-1 SU incl 19 str wins (6-3 ATS incl 2 str covers) in this series. LY UM was just off a loss to instate rival MSU & won 34-10 (-7) w/dominating 404-191 yd & 20-10 FD edges. LTH ('10) the gm was tied 21-21 at HT w/UM eventually winning 42-35 (-10). IU enters having lost 5 str & is off a 35-27 (+7) home loss to undefeated Iowa. The Hoosiers gained 407 yds, which was the most Iowa has all'd all ssn, but finished -60 yds. UM is off a 49-16 (-24) home win over Rutgers. After being outgd by over 150 yds in their 2 prev gms, the Wolverines were +262 yds LW & they are #2 in FBS all'g 154 ypg less than their foes avg. UM is +42 ypg away & +85 ypg in B10 action. IU is -17 ypg at home & -13 ypg in conf play. Despite many factors pointing in UM's favor, IU is a tough out and plays well against the upper echelon in the B10. The Hoosiers were only getting 7 pts LW at home against undefeated Iowa & now are getting nearly 2 td's at home this week? **FORECAST: MICHIGAN BY 4**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Georgia over AUBURN** - Bulldogs are 7-2 SU/6-3 ATS in this series. L2Y both have come in ranked and the L/time both have come in unranked was '09. LY UGA won 34-7 (-2) w/412-292 yd & 27-17 FD edges. LTH Auburn won 43-38 (-3) w/a combined 1,098 yds of offense. LW we used Auburn as a 2★ selection on these pages and the Tigers pulled an outright upset over Texas A&M 26-10 (+7). Aub had to go back to QB Johnson with QB White out with an inj (knee, CS) and relied on their run gm, picking up 311 rush yds as a team. Highly touted RB Robinson has gotten out of HC Malzahn's doghouse and led the way with 27-159-1. Aub outgd A&M 443-303 and had 3 int's off QB Murray who was making just his 2nd car start. Georgia is coming off a 27-3 (-16) win over Kentucky. UGA only had 90 yds passing but dominated three ground. RB Michel led the way with 24-165-1. The 'Dogs outgd the 'Cats 390-180 & outFD'd them 21-8. UGA is +97 ypg on the ssn. Aub is -48 ypg on the ssn and -42 ypg at home. Aub is 2-12 overall ATS & 3-9 vs SEC foes. We've had a great feel for Aub on these pages this ssn, winning with them LW & going against them the prev 2 wks. This gm concludes their SEC gauntlet of Ark, Miss, A&M & now UGA in 4 str wks & they figure to be worn down by the time the 4Q comes in this close gm. **FORECAST: GEORGIA BY 4**

**2★ CALIFORNIA over Oregon ST** - OSU is 12-4 SU/9-4 ATS in this series. LY Cal won 45-31 (+4) w/546-468 yd & 34-25 FD edges. LTH OSU won 49-17 (-10), led 28-3 at HT). The L/4 times OSU lost the ssn prior & seeking revenge they are 4-0 SU/ATS w/the avg cover by 17 ppq incl 2 outright upsets. That won't be the case this year. Cal is taking a step down in competition this week after playing at Utah, at UCLA, USC & at Oregon their L/4 gms. The Golden Bears are 1 win away from bowl elig & will be giving a max effort here with Stan & ASU on deck. The Golden Bears lost LW at Oregon 44-28 (+4). QB Goff struggled (18-41-329-2-1), but will have no problem turning things around against a Beaver pass D that ranks in the lower half of our pass eff D rankings. OSU is coming off their worst performance of the ssn in a 41-0 (+16) loss at home vs UCLA. OSU all'd a ssn high 674 yds while the 246 yds gained was their 2nd lowest output of the ssn. OSU is -101 ypg on the ssn, -212 ypg on the road, and -173 ypg in P12 play. Cal is +25 ypg on the ssn and +142 ypg at home. OSU is 3-8 ATS off a SU loss & on a 4-17 overall ATS run. **FORECAST: CALIFORNIA BY 28**

**2★ Miami, FI (+) over NORTH CAROLINA** - Miami is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series. LY the 'Canes won 47-20 (-16) but the gm was over at HT as they led 30-6 w/a 322-72 yd edge. LTH #10 UM trailed 17-13 at HT but eventually won 27-23 (-9) w/a 556-550 yd edge. LW NC looked like a true contender in their 66-31 (-7) dismantling of Duke at home. NC outgd their rival 704-533 and was +3 TO's in the process setting a ssn high in pts and yds. This was the 1st time NC ever scored 60+ pts vs Duke in series history. QB Williams set a car high with 494 pass yds and 4 tds. Miami is coming off a 27-21 (-5) home win over Virginia & is now 2-0 s/firing Al Golden. UM got QB Kaaya back from inj (20-26-286-2-1). UM outgd UVA 429-407 but was outFD'd 24-18. NC is +99 ypg in ACC play and +166 ypg at home. UM is -106 ypg in ACC play and -11 ypg on the road. Against two common foes, UM is +4 ppq but -13 ypg while the Tar Heels are +24 ppq and +120 ypg. NC has lost 2 str home finales (0-3 ATS run) & the 'Canes will keep this one close. **FORECAST: NORTH CAROLINA BY 6**

### WK 11 NOV 11 Wed

**Bowling Green at WESTERN MICHIGAN** - 1st place in the MAC East vs 1st place in the MAC West. BG is off to their best conf start s/'02. The Falcons are 0-4 SU/ATS in this series however, losing each by DD's (avg loss by 25 ppq). LY WM won 26-14 (+2) w/361-274 yd & 20-14 FD edges. LTH ('11) BG lost 45-21 (+10, -197 yds/-11 FD). We easily cashed our Wed Night Marquee LW with BG in their 62-24 (-20) home win over Ohio. QB Johnson has thrown for 300+ yds in every gm TY (10 str dating back to LY). His 33 td passes is #2 in FBS & he is just 365 yds short of setting the schls single ssn pass yds mark. WM is off a 54-7 (-14) home win over Ball St last Thurs. The Broncos finished with a schl rec 711 tll yds and held the Cards to just 7 FD & 152 yds! QB Terrell hit 16-22-324-3-0 & has a 13-0 ratio his L/5 gms. RB Bogan ran for a car high 171 (9.5) & has 9 td's his L/4 gms. WR Davis finished w/ ssn highs in yds (163) & tds (3) & has gone over 100 yds in 3 str gms. WM is #2 in FBS avg 212 ypg more than their foes allow, are +178 ypg away & +196 in MAC action. WM is much better at home (+178 ypg vs -6 ypg away) & is +204 ypg in conf play. BG is 8-3 as an AF, while WM is on a 14-5 reg ssn ATS run but are 4-8-1 as a HD.

**Northern Illinois at BUFFALO xx** - NIU is 8-1 SU (only series loss in 1968) & 5-2 ATS. Home tm is on a 3-0 ATS run. L/mtg ('12) NIU won 45-3 (-14) w/a 460-336 yd edge (-5 FD) & LTH ('11) won 31-30 (-14) but was up 31-10 in the 4Q (outgd by 244 yds & -18 FD). NIU has had an extra day to prepare following their come-from-behind 32-27 (+7) win on the road at Toledo last Tues. The Huskies are now back in the mix in the MAC West Div. The win was costly however, as NIU lost st'g QB Hare to an achilles. RfR QB Ryan Graham engineered 2 long 4Q scoring drives and finished hitting 9-12-132-1-0. The Huskies also lost 2nd leading WR Lewis to a knee inj (CS). Buff is off a come-from-behind 18-17 (-2) win on the road at Kent St last Thurs. Down 17-6, QB Licata threw two 4Q td passes incl the GW w/58 left. The Bulls all'd a ssn low

### NOV 12 Thurs

**Virginia Tech at GEORGIA TECH** - VT is 8-3 SU but 2-5 ATS in this series. LY VT had their 4-gm series win streak snapped, losing 27-24 (-7). LTH VT pulled the outright upset 17-10 (+7) limiting GT to just 129 rush yds (3.1). In the L/4 mtg's, VT has held GT below its ssn avg in rush ypg by 114 ypg. Both tms are off byes. The wk prior VT went on the road & beat BC 26-10 (-2), aff'g their ssn lows in rush (75) & tll (218) yds (5th time TY holding an opp under 280 yds). GT, meanwhile, off their FSU high was upset on the road at UVA the wk prior, 27-21 (-6). They all'd a ssn high 233 (5.5) rush yds & were held to just 144 rush yds & were forced to throw a ssn high 31 times (comp just 42%). At 3-6, GT will have to win out to reach a bowl (pressn #16 ranking). Yellow Jackets are much better at home (+149 ypg vs -101 ypg away), but are -23 ypg in ACC action. VT is +65 ypg away, but -12 ypg in conf play. GT is 14-9-1 ATS as a fav, while VT is on a 19-38-1 overall ATS run vs FBS foes.

**UL Lafayette at SOUTH ALABAMA** - Home tm is 3-0 SU/ATS w/an avg MOV of 18 ppq (+8) ppq avg cover). LY ULL won 19-9 (-7) after trailing 9-6 at HT (412-336 yd & 22-18 FD edge). LTH SA won 30-8 (-3) w/363-212 yd & 22-12 FD edges. ULL is off a 23-21 (-2) win on the road at Ga St. The Ragin' Cajuns got a 21 yd game deciding fg w/6:59 left, but missed a 42 yd fg w/under 3 min left that would have made their backers happy. LTH #23 USC led 23-0 at HT (206-63 yd edge) on their way to a 47-29 (-21) win. USC is off a tougher than expected 38-30 (-19) home win over AZ. The Trojans were down by 3 entering the 4Q, but lead 38-23 & all'd a td w/10 left. USC had a 472-412 yd edge & RB Jones ran for 177 (9.3) incl a 74 yd td run. CU had been playing competitive leading up to their 42-10 (+16) home loss to Stan LW. The Buff's were held to ssn lows in FD (15) & yds (231). Against 3 common foes (ASU, Stan, AZ) USC is 2-1 SU/1-2 ATS, +9 ppq & +4 ypg. CU is 0-3 SU/1-2 ATS, -22 ppq & -143 ypg. USC is 11-21 as an AF, while CU is 10-3 ATS at home.

**DUKE by 1 over Pittsburgh** - This is Duke's home finale & they're 4-1 ATS in that role incl B2B SU wins by 19 ppq. In this series the Blue Devils are 3-7 SU, but 2-0 ATS as ACC rivals & this is just the 3rd meeting s/76. LY Duke prevailed in 2OT 51-48 (+3) but were outgd 594-438 & outFD'd 37-25 (both all'd ssn highs). LTH Pitt won 58-55 (-4) w/1130 comb yds & 50 FD's. Duke was humiliated by rival NC on the road LW, 66-31 (+7). It was the most pts Duke all'd in series history & they all'd ssn highs in yds (704) & FD's (29). Pitt is off a 42-30 (+9) home loss to ND. They were down 21-3 at HT. The Blue Devils are +92 ypg at home, but -48 ypg in ACC action. The Panthers are +56 ypg away & +29 ypg in conf play. Duke is 21-11-1 ATS overall & 17-9-1 as a HF, however Pitt is 5-1 ATS away.

**CINCINNATI by 17 over Tulsa** - Cincy is 5-2 SU in home finales. The Bearcats have won 4 str in this series, but the L/mtg was in '97. LW UC nearly pulled the upset at undefeated Houston, but lost 33-30 (+9). QB Kiel threw for a car high 523 yds & 4 td's, but the Bearcats were SOD from their own 42 w/just over a min left. UC did finish w/a 589-427 yd edge. It was the most yds UH has all'd & they were held to their 2nd lowest yds tll. Tulsa is off a 45-30 (-16) home win over winless UCF. The Golden Hurricane were up 24-3 at HT & 45-23 late 4Q & all'd a gbg td w/1:04 left to leave their backers furious. Both teams are 1 win away from bowl elig. TU is +34 ypg away, but -49 ypg in AAC action. CU is +286 ypg at home & +273 ypg in conf play! The Bearcats are also #2 in FBS avg 201 ypg more than their foes allow. Cincy is 20-12 ATS off a SU loss, but TU is on a 7-4 ATS run & is 6-1 as an AD.

**CHARLOTTE by 3 over Utsa** - First mtg. Charlotte began plying FB in '13 while UTSA str'd its program in '11. 49ers home finale and they are 0-3-1 as a HD, while UTSA is 5-2 as an AF. Charlotte enters on a 7 gm losing streak & are off a 48-31 (+17) loss on the road at FIU. The 49ers were down 34-10 at HT & gained 155 of their 395 yds in two 4Q td drives. UTSA has dropped 4 str & is off a 36-31 (-8) home loss to ODU. The Roadrunners took a 1 pt lead on a 39 yd fg w/7:21 left, but then all'd the game deciding td on ODU's next drive & were SOD their final 2 drives. UTSA was -124 yds as they all'd ODU to finish with a ssn high 548 yds, nearly 200 yds more than their avg. Charlotte is -27 ypg at home, but -165 ypg in CUSA action. UTSA is -48 ypg away & -91 ypg in conf play.

**Umass by 10 over EASTERN MICHIGAN** - This is EM's home finale & they are 1-5 SU/ATS incl 3 str losses by 26 ppq in that role. These schls met for the 1st time LY with UMass winning 36-14 (-14) w/562-280 yd & 34-11 FD edges. The yds/FD's all'd were ssn highs & the FD's were a ssn high for the Minutemen. EM enters on an 8 gm losing streak & is off a 28-13 (+4) loss on the road at Miami, Oh. The Eagles were down 21-3 at HT & were outgd 441-192 & outFD'd 21-10 in the gm. Their yds & FD's were ssn lows. UMass has dropped 5 str after their 17-13 (-2) home loss to Akron LW. The Minutemen led 13-7 at HT, but were shutout in the 2H & were held to their 2nd lowest yds total of the ssn. UMass is -145 ypg away & -112 ypg in MAC action. EM is -98 ypg at home & -161 ypg in conf play. The Eagles are 9-24-1 ATS & 13-32 ATS at home. UMass is 0-7 ATS vs MAC foes & 1-5 off a SU loss.

**Middle Tennessee by 1 over FLORIDA ATLANTIC** - This series started in '03 as both were SBC members & they've ply'd every ssn since. MT has won 7 str & is 9-1 SU/7-3 ATS. LY MT won 35-34 (-7) being outgd 540-470 (+2 FD). MT trailed 34-21 4Q but scored the final 14 pts incl a GW 12-yd td pass w/19. LTH MT escaped in OT 42-35 (-3, -57 yds/-7 FD). FAU enters having lost 4 of 5 & is off a 35-19 (+24) loss on the road at WKU. They were outgd by 150 yds, but were just -2 FD's. MT has won 2 of 3 & was fortunate in their 27-24 (-3) 3OT home win over Marshall. After missing the GW 31 yd fg in 2OT, Clark connected on a 46 yd fg & the Blue Raiders blk'd Marshall's attempt to tie. The Herd missed 5 fg's in the gm & were using their KO specialist, who had never att'd a fg in OT. Against 4 common foes (Char, WKU, FIU, Marsh) MT is 3-1 SU/1-2-1 ATS, +10 ppq & +114 ypg. FAU is 2-2 SU/2-1-1 ATS, -1 ppq & -50 ypg. The dog is 16-2-1 in FAU gms & the Owls are 22-9 as a dog, but MT is 14-8 as an AF.

**MARSHALL by 14 over FIU** - Marshall is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series & has won 6 str home finales (3-3 ATS). FIU will be making their 1st ever trip to Huntington. LY #25 MU won 45-13 (-21) w/a 457-385 yd edge (-5 FD). The yds were a CUSA low for MU. Marshall enters off their 1st conf loss, 27-24 (+3) in 3 OT. The Thundering Herd were done in by kicking woes as they missed 5 fg's & were using their KO specialist who had never att'd a fg in the OT sessions. FIU has alternated wins & losses their L/5 gms & are off a 48-31 (-17) home win over Charlotte. The Golden Panthers were up 48-24, but all'd a 87/16pl drive that ended with a gbg td w/1:54 left to infuriate their backers. Against 4 common foes (ODU, MT, FAU, Char) Marshall is 3-1 SU/3-0-1 ATS, +15 ppq & +122 ypg. FIU is 2-2 SU/2-1-1 ATS, +6 ppq & -64 ypg. MU is 9-4-1 as a HF, but FIU is on a 14-7-2 ATS run & is 7-3 as an AD incl 6-1 as a CUSA AF.

**Akron by 10 over MIAMI, OH** - This is the home finale in Oxford & Miami has dropped 4 str in that role (2-6-2 ATS). In this series, Miami is 12-4 SU/8-5-3 ATS & the home team is 9-4-3 ATS. LY UA won 29-19 (-15) being outgd 352-318 (+1 FD). LTH the gm was tied 7-7 at HT (UA 206-109 yd edge) before the Zips won 24-17 (-7). Akron is off a 17-13 (+2) win on the road at UMass LW. Defense continues to be their calling card as they held the Minutemen to their 2nd lowest yds of the ssn & are #11 in FBS holding foes to 96 yds below their ssn avg! The Zips are still playing with a chance to go bowling. Miami snapped an 8 gm losing streak & won their 1st gm over an FBS foe in their 28-13 (-4) home win over EM. The Redhaws all'd ssn lows in yds (192) & FD's (10) as they held EM to 223 yds below their avg. This is the 3rd str home gm for Miami & they are +2 ypg at home, but -49 ypg in MAC action. Akron is travelling in B2B wks & is -49 ypg away & even in yds in conf play. The Zips are just 3-12-1 as an AF.

**MICHIGAN ST by 21 over Maryland** - Just the 2nd mtg s/50 (LTH). LY #12 MSU won 37-15 (-11) w/482-252 yd & 23-11 FD edges. The wk prior Ohio St had just eliminated MSU from a possible playoff berth & on deck for Sparty are the Buckeyes. MSU had their undefeated ssn taken away in their 39-38 (-5) loss on the road at Neb LW. Up by 12 w/under 2 min left, MSU all'd 2 td's, the last covering 91/4pl highlighted by a 30 yd td pass that the ref's all'd after a video review despite the Neb WR going out of bounds on his own & then coming back onto the field to make the catch w/17 left. The Spartans dominant D was shredded for 499 yds, easily their most all'd all ssn & it was also the most yds Neb had gained on a P5 Conf tm this ssn. MD has lost 6 str & LW had their bowl hopes officially come to an end after their 31-24 (+10) home loss to Wisc. The Terrapins were down 31-17 late 4Q & went 76/9pl to score a td w/2:39 remaining for the backdoor cover. MD is -84 ypg away & -65 ypg in B10 action. MSU is surprisingly just +19 ypg at home, but are +109 ypg in conf play. MSU is 1-7 ATS as a fav, but are 4-0 ATS off a SU loss, while MD is 11-5 as an AD, but 3-5 as a DD dog.

**HOUSTON by 6 over Memphis** - A wk ago this gm appeared to be the "AAC GOY" as both teams were undefeated, but Memphis didn't hold up its end of the bargain. Now only UH will be playing with a chance at a NYD bowl. UH has dominated this series, winning 5 str & covering 4 str. LY the Cougars pulled the outright upset 28-24 (+7) but UM had 368-354 yd & 20-15 FD edges (UH +2 TO). LTH UH won 25-15 (-7) being out'd 349-247 & outFD'd 20-15 (+3 TO). UH was out'd for the 1st time TY in their 33-30 (-9) home win over Cincy as they all'd a ssn high 589 yds incl 523 thru the air! They were out'd by 162 yds. We cashed our top LPS totals play on the OVER in Memphis' 45-20 (-7) home loss to Navy. The Tigers had been playing with fire for much of the ssn as they had been down by DD in 4 prev gms. Memphis doesn't have exp defending the option & it showed as they all'd a ssn high 374 (5.7) rush yds. They hadn't all'd over 200 rush yds to any foe entering the gm. The Tigers are +118 ypg away & +65 ypg in AAC action. UH is +131 ypg at home & +119 in conf play. UH is on a 23-11-1 ATS run & is 30-17 ATS as a fav, but UM is 6-1-1 as an AD.

**Ohio St by 14 over ILLINOIS** - OSU has won 7 str (5-2 ATS) in this series since their upset loss as the #1 ranked tm in '07. LY OSU led 31-0 at HT (284-112 yd edge) eventually winning 55-14 (-28). LTH the Buckeyes won 60-35 (-34, +171 yds). The defending Nat'l Champion Buckeyes were up 21-0 in the 4Q at home LW vs MN, but all'd the Gophers to score 2 td's (155 of their 314 td yds on those 2 drives) to make it close. QB Jones continued to struggle as the str, but OSU will get the return of JT Barrett (Susp) and the offense will be back to normal. RB Elliott ran for over 100 yds for an FBS high 9th gm this ssn & 14th gm str. Illinois ply'd their best gm of the ssn LW, a 48-14 (-3) win on the road at Purdue. The Illini had ssn highs in FD's (29) & yds (595, also most PU has all'd) while holding PU to their 2nd lowest yds tll (263) just 1 wk after PU had their FBS high in yds. Illinios got the much needed return of versatile RB Ferguson. OSU does have MSU on deck and are +201 ypg away & +128 ypg in B10 action. Illinois is +17 ypg at home & -2 ypg in conf action. UI is 5-0 ATS vs OSU when ranked in the top 5 & is 8-4 as a HD.

**Clemson by 17 over SYRACUSE** - This is just the 4th all-time meeting between these new ACC rivals. CU is 2-0 SU in ACC matchups & the visitor is 2-0 ATS. LY the Tigers trailed at HT 6-3 but won 16-6 (-14) w/375-170 yd & 23-10 FD edges. LTH #3 CU won 49-14 (-14, +227 yds & +14 FD). We cashed our College GOY (now 27-7 all time) LW going against CU in their 23-13 (-10) home win over FSU. Clemson was fortunate as the Noles threw an int from the Tiger 20 as they were looking to take a 14-0 lead & got a 4&1 stop from their 40 mid 4Q. SU enters on a 6 gm losing streak & is off a 41-17 (+14) loss on the road at L'Ville. The Orange were dominated & finished -293 yds. SU is -20 ypg at home & -149 in ACC action. Clemson is #6 in FBS avg 170 ypg more than their foes are all'g, #4 in FBS holding foes to 127 ypg less than they avg, are +261 ypg away & +255 in conf play. CU is however, 2-4 as an AF & are in a letdown spot following their emotional win LW.

**Temple by 7 over USF** - The last/only mtg in this series was in '12. Temple got the outright upset 37-28 (+3). First visit to Raymond James Stadium for the Owls but they also play in an NFL venue. We cashed our Fri night Marquee on Temple LW in their 60-40 (-13) win on the road at SMU. It was the most pts the Owls have scored s/73 (63 vs Holy Cross) & they finished w/a 536-397 yd edge. Temple is 5-0 away for the 1st time in scht hist. RB Thomas ply'd w/inj'd ribs (scored a td in all 9 gms & just 30 yds shy of 1,000) & true frosh RB Gardner set a scht rec w/a 94 yd td run. QB Walker tied his car high with 4 td passes. USF has won 4 of 5 & are off an outright 22-17 (+4) road win at EC. The Bulls were +222 yds & +14 FDs as they held EC to a ssn low 220 yds, nearly 200 yds below their avg. This is the 1st of B2B home gms for USF & they're +137 ypg at home, but -16 ypg in AAC action. Temple is -38 ypg away, but +57 ypg in conf play. The Owls are 11-3 ATS overall & 13-5 ATS away, while USF is just 9-19-1 ATS at home incl 6-11-1 as a HD.

**Nebraska by 14 over RUTGERS** - Just the 3rd overall mtg & 2nd gm s/20. LY NU won 42-24 (-20) w/a 455-348 yd edge (+6 FD). Nebraska has had a nightmare type of ssn, but their players actually went to bed with happy thoughts following their 39-38 (+5) outright upset at home over undefeated MSU LW. The Huskers were down 38-26 late 4Q, but scored 2 td's in the final 2 min highlighted by a 30 yd GW td pass w/17 left that officials all'd to stand after review despite the WR going out of bounds on his own & re-entering the field to make the catch. NU finished with 499 yds, which was the most MSU had all'd TY. RU had dropped 4 of 5 incl 3 str by an avg score of 49-11 after their 49-16 (+24) loss on the road at Michigan. RU has been held under 300 yds in those 3 str gms & have all'd over 425 yds against all but 1 (Kansas) of their FBS foes. NU is now playing with a legit shot at landing a bowl bid & are -4 ypg away & -10 ypg in conf play. Rut is -4 ypg at home, but -184 ypg in B10 action & have been out'd by an avg of 253 ypg their L/3. NU is 9-3-1 ATS away from Lincoln.

**OLD DOMINION by 4 over Utep** - This is just the 2nd all-time meeting & UTEP is making a rare trip East. LY in the initial meeting, UTEP won at home, 42-35 (-3, led 21-7 at HT) w/465-357 yd & 23-16 FD edges. The Miners are off an outright upset home win over Rice, 24-21 (+6) last Fri. Tied at 21, UTEP went 73/16pl, utilizing 7:25 of the clock & hit the GW 24 yd fg w/53 left. The Miners continue to play better s/ the return of QB Leftwich. They finished with their most rush yds s/wk 3 & all'd ssn lows in rush (96) & tll (326) yds. ODU is also off an outright upset win, 36-31 (+8) on the road at UTSA. The Monarchs had a ssn high 548 yds (2nd most yds all'd by UTSA). ODU is just -131 ypg at home & -20 ypg in CUSA action. UTEP is -203 ypg away & -93 ypg in conf play. ODU is 1-8 overall ATS, 1-10 ATS at home & 1-5 ATS as a fav all time vs FBS foes. UTEP is 4-7-2 ATS overall, 5-14 as an AD & is 0-19-1 SU in gms ply'd in the Eastern time zone!

**TCU by 49 over Kansas** - TCU is 3-0 SU but KU has covered each and at HT in the Big 12 mtg's the Jayhawks have been down by just 4, tied & led by 3. LY TCU won 34-30 (-28) with only a 463-418 yd edge (+5 FD). TCU had just faced #9 K-St & off 5 ranked B12 opp's in a 6 gm stretch. LTH TCU won 27-17 (-24, +182 yds) but the wk prior lost at #11 OU & had #21 OSU on deck. Clearly TCU hasn't brought their "A" gm with them vs KU. The Horned Frogs had their Nat'l Title bubble burst in a very misleading 49-29 (-5) road loss at OSU. TCU finished with 663-456 yd & 36-16 FD edges but QB Boykin tossed a car high 4 int's & WR Dotson was inj (wrist) and is questionable (CS). TCU has a road gm at OU on deck & Baylor on a short wk after that. KU continues to be an embarrassment for the B12 as they're off a 59-20 (+28) loss on the road at TX. It was the 5th time they've all'd 55+ pts. They are #125 in FBS avg 127 ypg less on offense than their foes allow & #125 all'g 113 ypg more than their foes avg. TCU is 11-1 ATS at home incl 9-1 as a HF, while KU is 2-9 overall ATS & 15-28-1 as an AD.

**TEXAS TECH by 4 over Kansas St** - K-St has won 4 str SU/ATS. LY K-St won 45-13 (-14) holding TT to a ssn low 347 yds (-157 below ssn avg) & TT's 13 FD's tied a ssn low. LTH K-St pulled the outright upset 49-26 (+2) over #25 TT but were out'd 459-367 (+11 FD). K-St was +3 TO incl a 43 yd IR td. K-St comes in with extra rest as we easily cashed a Thurs night Marquee with the Wildcats in their 31-24 (+17) home loss to Baylor. QB Hubener had 304 td yds incl 153 (5.3) rush & K-St had a chance to tie the gm, but threw an int w/under a min left. TT has lost 3 str & are coming off a 31-26 (+8) loss on the road at WV in which they were held to ssn lows in pass yds (199) tll yds (378) & FD's (23). This will be the Red Raiders 11th str wk of action. Against 4 common foes (TCU, OU, OSU, Bay) KSU is 0-4 SU/3-1 ATS, -17 ppg & -212 ypg. TT is 0-4 SU/ATS, -21 ppg & -97 ypg. K-St is 40-16 ATS vs B12 foes & 25-12 as a dog, while TT is 6-10 as a HF.

**VANDERBILT by 3 over Kentucky** - VU has covered 4 str but LY UK snapped its longest series losing streak (3) s/91-95 (5 gms). UK won 17-7 (-17). UK had a 384-139 yd & 23-8 FD edge (both D bests on yr). LTH UK only trailed 9-6 at HT but lost 22-6 (+11). UK has lost 4 str & are off a 27-3 (+16) loss on the road at UGA in which they were held to ssn lows in pass (101) & tll (180) yds & also FD's (8) while all'g a ssn high 300 (5.8) rush. VU is off a 9-7 (+20) loss on the road at UF. The 'Dores D forced 4 TO's, but

ahead by 1 mid 4Q, had a 12 yd punt that gave UF poss at the VU 45 & they then went 20/6pl kicking the GW 43 yd fg w/2:22 to play. VU has been held under 45 yds passing in 2 str gms & has been held under 190 tll yds in B2B gms. Their D remains the strength as they are actually #10 in FBS holding foes to 105 ypg less than their avg. Vs 4 common foes (SC, UF, MO, UGA) UK is 2-2 SU/ATS, -4 ppg & -51 ypg. VU is 1-3 SU/3-1 ATS, -6 ppg & -20 ypg. UK is 7-21-2 vs SEC foes.

**NORTHWESTERN by 21 over Purdue** - This is the home finale in Evanston & NW is 1-3 SU/ATS in that role. NW is 5-3 SU/ATS in this series, but the Visitor has gone 3-0 SU w/THREE outright upsets. LY NW won 38-14 (+1, up 24-7 at HT) w/a 414-312 yd edge. LTH (10) PU won 20-17 (+8). NW is off a 23-21 (-1) home win over PSU, as they finished with their most rush yds (227, 4.8) in conf action. PU couldn't capitalize off their feel good win over Neb 2 wks ago, as they were absolutely embarrassed in their 48-14 (+3) home loss to Illinois. The Boilermakers all'd ssn highs in rush (382) & tll (595) yds as they were out'd by 332 yds. The Wildcats are +86 ypg at home, but -75 ypg in B10 action. PU is -92 ypg away & -165 ypg in conf play. NW is 17-31-1 as a fav incl 4-9 as a HF, while the Boilermakers are 10-5 as an AD.

**AIR FORCE by 3 over Utah St** - This is the home finale for AF & they've won 5 of 6 SU in that role incl an outright upset as a 7' pt dog LY. This is just the 3rd mtg between these schls s/69. UTSt is 2-0 SU/ATS in both MW mtg's. The Aggies have covered by an avg of 16' ppg & LY held AF to 118 rush yds below its ssn avg (155, 3.0) & LTH 101 yds below (162, 3.3). UTSt has lost 2 of 3 incl AF being outright upset 14-13 (-16) on the road at NM LW. The Aggies trailed 14-3 mid 3Q but came back & had a chance to take the lead, but their 41 yd fg w/under a min left was no good. UTSt was held to under 300 yds for the 3rd time & 2nd in their L/3 gms, but they did hold NM's triple option offense to ssn lows in rush (132, 2.8) & tll 236 yds (145 below their avg). AF has won 4 of 5 incl 3 str & are off a 20-3 (-17) home win over rival Army. It was their 2nd str gm holding their opponent under 180 tll yds, as they finished +183 yds. The Falcons are +202 ypg at home & +171 ypg in MW action. UTSt is travelling for the 2nd str wk & 3rd time in 4W & are -3 ypg away & +78 ypg in conf play. AF is 10-4-1 ATS overall incl 8-2-1 ATS at home, but UTSt is 32-19 as an AD.

**TEXAS ST by 3 over Georgia St** - This is just the 3rd all-time mtg, but the 3rd str ssn playing. TXSt is 2-0 SU but the Visitor has covered both prior gms. LY the Bobcats won 54-31 (-14, led 27-3 at HT) as TXSt put up an FBS ssn high 607 yds & 29 FD (all'd 516, 24). LTH TXSt won 24-17 (-16). GSt has lost 5 of 6 & are off a 23-21 (+2) home loss to ULL. They were fortunate to lose by just 2 as ULL missed a 42 yd fg w/ under 3 min left. TXSt has also lost 5 of 6 & are off an upset home loss to NMSU, 31-21 (-17). The Bobcats were again done in by their D as they all'd 525+ yds for the 6th time & are #126 in FBS all'g 140 ypg more than their opponents avg. TXSt cannot just blame their horrible rush D (286 ypg, 5.8 ypc) as they have our worst ranked pass eff D, all'g 20 td passes w/o having an int & they are taking on a Panther offense led by QB Ar buckle who is avg 333 pass ypg w/a 16-8 ratio. The Bobcats have a gm in just 5 days on deck. TXSt is 1-4 ATS overall & 5-8 as a HF. GSt is 16-8-1 as a dog vs FBS foes & 12-3 as an AD.

**Arkansas ST by 17 over ULM** - ASU has won 5 str SU/ATS. LY the Red Wolves won 28-14 (-12) after a scoreless 1H. ASU had a 572-348 yd & 29-16 FD edge. LTH it was tied 14-14 at HT but ASU eventually won 42-14 (+3, +166 yds/7 FD). ASU took control of the SBC with a 40-27 (+11) win on the road at App St last Thurs. The Redwolves were down 21-14 late 2Q, but then scored 26 str. RB Gordon ran for 136 (8.0). ULM has a road gm in 5 days on deck & is off 3 str AG's & this marks their only HG in a 6W period. In their last gm they were crushed at Troy, 51-14 (+9) as they all'd the Trojans to gain a ssn high 493 yds & finished -117 yds & -6 TO's! The Warhawks are -65 ypg at home & -162 ypg in SBC action. ASU is -70 ypg away, but +51 ypg in conf play. The Red Wolves are 4-6 ATS away incl 2-4 as an AF, but ULM is 3-9 ATS at home incl 0-3-1 as a HD.

**UCLA by 10 over Washington St** - This is the home finale in the Rose Bowl & UCLA is 0-3 SU/ATS in that role. UCLA has won 5 str in this series, but WSt has covered each of the L/3. L/mtg (12) '17 UCLA led 37-7 at HT & only won 44-36 (-16). LTH (11) UCLA trailed at the half 9-7 but won 28-25 (-3). The Bruins have won 3 str after their 41-0 (-16) shutout on the road at OSU. UCLA finished w/a ssn high 674 yds (also most OSU has all'd) & held the Beavers to their 2nd lowest yds mark of the ssn & finished +428 yds! Wazzu has won 4 of 5 & are coming off a 38-24 (-2) home win over ASU. The Cougars finished w/512 yds incl 497 thru the air & they now have su up the most yds that their opponents have all'd in 3 str gms! Against 5 common foes (Cal, ASU, AZ, WSU, ODU) UCLA is 3-2 SU/ATS, +9 ppg & +109 ypg. Wazzu is 3-2 SU/5-0 ATS, +6 ppg & +79 ypg. UCLA is 1-5 ATS at home incl 3-7 as a HF, while WSU is 12-3 ATS away & 20-10 as an AD.

**WEST VIRGINIA by 7 over Texas** - TX has won 2 str SU/ATS after being outright upset in '12 (first Big12 mtg). LY TX won 33-16 (+3) but was out'd 448-351 (-5 FD). LTH the Horns trailed at HT 19-13 but prevailed in OT 47-40 (-5). WV is off a 31-26 (-8) home win over TT. WVU had 449-378 yd & 28-23 FD edges. The WV D held TT to their lowest output of the ssn (228 yds below their ssn avg). The Mountaineers 3-3-5 confused TT and held them to less than 200 yds passing. TX is coming off a blowout home win over Kansas, 59-20 (-28). The Longhorns had a 598-426 edge but were outFD'd 23-20. TX is in a must win situation. The Longhorns need 2 wins in its final 3 gms to be bowl eligible and WV also needs 2 wins but faces a much easier road. WV is +172 ypg at home but -83 ypg in B12 play. TX is -197 ypg on the road and -38 ypg in B12 play. WV is 7-15 as a HF.

**NOTRE DAME by 31 over Wake Forest** - ND is 2-0 SU (only prior mtg's) & the home tm is 2-0 ATS. In the L/mtg (12, also LTH) #3 ND pulled the shutout 38-0 (-24) w/584-209 yd & 23-9 FD edges (both def ssn bests). This is ND's only HG in the L5W & they had won 4 str home finales until LY's outright upset. WF is fresh off a bye & a 20-19 (+11) Fri home loss to Louisville the wk prior. The Deacons had a 19-17 HT lead, but had five 2H TO's. WF was held to under 300 yds for the 3rd time in their L/4 gms. ND is coming off a 42-30 (-9) win at Pitt. ND had 437-398 yd & 22-18 FD edges. QK Kizer accounted for 6 tds in the gm which tied a modern day ND scht rec. ND is +144 ypg at home while the Deacons are -50 ypg away. WF is 3-8 as an AD, but ND is 5-13 as a DD fav. ND is on an 8-2 ATS run.

**Alabama by 8 over MISSISSIPPI ST** - Bama has won 7 str but MSU has covered 3 of 4 incl 2 str. LY #4 Bama beat #1 MSU 25-20 (-9) but was out'd 428-335 & outFD'd 26-17. The Tide did lead 19-3 at HT. LTH Bama won 20-7 (-24) with solid 383-197 yd & 20-10 FD edges. MSU is off a 31-13 (-8) win on the road at MO last Thurs. The Bulldogs only led 14-13 at HT, but picked it up in the 2H as QB Prescott threw for 303 yds & 4 td's & became the 10th pl'r in SEC hist with 10,000 yds of tll offense & the 6th pl'r to account for 100 td's! LW Bama completely controlled LSU in a 30-16 (-7) home win. Bama held LSU to a ssn low 182 yds w/a 28-12 FD edge. RB Henry solidified his Heisman campaign, going 38-210-3 while RB Fournette was held to just 19-31-1. Bama controlled the LOS and the clock with over 39 min of TOP. The Crimson Tide are +158 ypg and +131 ypg on the road but will be tested by MSU who is +141 ypg at home. Bama's D has all'd 184 ypg less than their foes avg which is tops in the FBS. Bama is 3-7 as an AF. MSU is 8-1 as an SEC dog & 6-2 as a conf HD. The Crimson Tide are 0-4 ATS after beating LSU.

**Southern Miss by 10 over RICE** - This is homecoming weekend in Houston. Rice is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series. LY Rice won 41-23 (-8) w/395-323 yd & 20-18 FD edges. LTH (12) Rice won 44-17 (-3) but was out'd (-2 yds) taking advantage of +2 TO incl a 76 yd IR td. SM is off a bye & became bowl elig w/a 34-13 (-24) home win vs UTEP the wk prior. RB Richard had his 3rd str gm over 100 yds & QB Mullens had his 2nd str gm with a 4-0 ratio. WR Thompson had a car high 10 rec's for 112 yds & 2 td's as the Eagles finished +225 yds. SM has 5 str gms where they have finished at least +162 in yds & are +64 ypg away & +230 ypg in CUSA action. Rice is coming off an upset loss on the road at UTEP 24-21 (-6) last Fri. The Owls all'd the GW 24 yd fg w/53 left, but had a chance at the end but their final desperation pass was inc in the EZ. Rice was -3 in FD & -66 yds. WR Wright had his 1st car 100 yd gm, finishing with 116. Rice is on a 26-15-1 ATS run & is 17-7-1 as a HF, but SM is 8-3 ATS overall & 7-3 as an AD.

**NAVY by 24 over Smu** - This is the home finale for Navy & they've won 2 tm in that role (4-1 ATS). In this series, Navy is 8-1 SU/6-2 ATS winning 5 str (Loss in '98). In the L/mtg (11) Navy got their 2nd str outright upset 24-17 (+8). LTH (10) Navy won 35-17 (+6). We cashed our Fri night Marquee going against SMU in their 60-40 (+13) home loss to Temple. QB Davis accounted for 269 of the Ponies 397 tll yds. SMU all'd 268 (7.2) rush yds. We cashed our top weekly LPS Total on the OVER in Navy's big upset win over Memphis 45-20 (+7) LW that suddenly has Navy in position to win the AAC West. Navy out'd UM 459-438 and was +3 TO's. Navy dominated the ground game with 374 rush yds while also holding UM to their 2nd lowest offensive output of the ssn. This looks to be a good matchup for Navy, as SMU has all'd 260 rush ypg (5.8) on the ssn. SMU is -113 ypg on the ssn and -123 ypg on the road. Navy is +34 ypg on the ssn and +71 ypg at home. Navy is 6-1 ATS at home & SMU is 10-15 as an AD.

The Green Wave defended the triple option extremely well when they traveled to Navy 3 wks ago, holding them to ssn lows in rush 133 (2.5) & tll (291) yds. They actually finished +95 yds but were done in by -3 TO's. TU is 5-2 ATS overall & will be able to defend the option and get the call as our Underdog play of the week!

ISU is -43 ypg on the ssn and -67 ypg in B12 play. OSU is +107 ypg and +56 ypg in B12 play. ISU's home finale. ISU is 4-2-2 as a HD vs Top 10 tms. OSU is 30-19 as a DD fav & 18-11 as an AF.

**LSU by 13 over Arkansas** - Revenge for LSU. LSU is 8-4 SU but Ark is on a 8-2 ATS series run incl 3 str covers. LY LSU was embarrassed 17-0 (-1) being held to ssn lows in yds (123) & FD's (12). With the win Arkansas ended a 17-gm SEC losing skid. The loss came the wk after facing Bama (OT defeat). LTH LSU won 31-27 (-26, trailed 17-14 at HT). LW LSU was dominated by Bama 30-16 (+7). LSU was held to a ssn low 182 yds of offense. Bama completely controlled the LOS and held RB Fournette to 19-31-1 while QB Harris could not take advantage going 6-19-128-1-1 incl just 3-14 (21.4%) on throws of 15 yds or less. LSU all'd Bama to control the clock for over 39 min and RB Henry won 38-210-3. LSU was outgd' 434-182 & outFD'd 28-12. LW we used Ark as a 4★ LPS (almost 5★ GOY which won w/FSU) and the Razorbacks won outright in a wild 53-52 OT win (+10). UA has scored 50+ pts in 3 str games for the 1st time s/ '16! QB Allen had the best gm of his career, going 33-45-442-6-0 and ran for the GW 2 pt conv. LSU is +101 ypg on the ssn and +191 ypg at home while Ark is +60 ypg on the ssn and just +1 ypg on the road. Ark is 8-2-1 as an SEC dog.

**ARIZONA STATE by 10 over Washington** - ASU HC. The Sun Devils have dominated this series winning 9 str SU/ATS w/ the avg cover by 9 ypg. LY ASU led 10-0 at HT eventually winning 24-10 (-3) being outgd' 290-285 & outFD'd 19-14. LTH ASU beat #20 Wash 53-24 (-3, up 29-7 at HT) w/a 585-212 yd edge (+19 FD). ASU is coming off its 3rd str loss, 38-24 vs WSU (+2). Things looked good for ASU early as they jumped out to a 14-0 lead but WSU fought back. ASU was outgd' 512-458 but outFD'd WSU 24-22. A key play in the gm happened when WSU was SOD at the ASU11 but an inadvertent whistle gave WSU a 2nd chance which turned into a td. UW is off a tough 34-23 (-2) loss to Utah. The Huskies outgd' Utah 381-346 but had 4 TO's incl a FR td. UW only trailed 24-23 in the 4Q but Utah scored 10 pts at the end of the 4Q to pull away. UW is -151 ypg on the road and -67 ypg in P12 action while ASU is +127 ypg at home + 40 ypg in P12 action. ASU is 2-9 ATS overall. UW HC Petersen is 14-8 as a dog.

**BAYLOR by 7 over Oklahoma** - OU started this series 20-0 but the L4Y BU has gone 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS. LY #10 BU led 24-14 at HT over #16 OU on their way to a 48-14 (+5) outright upset (544-319 yd & 31-13 FD edge). LTH #5 BU won 41-12 (-16) over #12 OU w/dominating 459-237 yd & 28-16 FD edges. The Bears do have 2 extra days of rest as we cashed a Thurs night Marq going vs them in their 31-24 (-17) win at K-St. BU led 31-10 4Q and for the gm had a 522-430 yd edge (-2 FD). Fr QB Stidham in his 1st career start went 23-33-70%-419-3-0 w/a rush td. This will begin a tough 4-gm gauntlet as BU's next 3 opp's all will be ranked. LW we used Oklahoma as the 4★ Top Selection on these pages and OU didn't disappoint in a 52-16 (-24) romp over Iowa St. OU outgd' ISU 684-374 & outFD'd them 28-22. The was OU's 4th str gm scoring over 50 pts and they have now outgd' foes by 360 ypg in that stretch! OU's next 3 opp's have a combined rec of 25-1 and will also be mkt'd. BU is +328 ypg at home and +174 ypg in B12 play but OU is +239 ypg on the road and +235 ypg in B12 play. Baylor is 27-10 as a HF, but OU is 12-6 ATS away & 9-4 as an AD.

**BYU by 6 over MISSOURI** - Played at Arrowhead Stadium (home to NFL's Chiefs). Only prior mtg was the '83 Holiday Bowl, BYU won 21-17. Mizzou is off a Thurs night home loss to MSU 31-13 (+8). The Tigers only trailed 14-13 at HT but could only muster 115 yds in the 2H. Mizzou all'd ssn highs in pass (303) & tll (430) yds & the 23 FD all'd tied their most all'd. They did score a td for the 1st time in over a month & had a ssn high 215 (4.8) rush yds, but at 4-5 are likely to miss a bowl with a lifeless offense (L/2 yrs SEC East Champs). BYU survived a close call last Fri, holding on to beat SJSU on the road, 17-16 (-13) as the Spartans 2 pt conv with :45 left failed. The Cougars were held to their lowest FD (17) & yds (329) s/ their loss at Mich, but QB Mangum tied the schl rec for most td passes by a frosh (15, Jake Heaps in '10). MO is 7-1 ATS off a SU loss, but BYU is 6-2 ATS in the 2nd gm of B2B road gms.

**Georgia Southern by 10 over TROY** - Troy is 5-2 SU/ATS in home finales. Troy is 10-4 SU but this is just the 2nd mtg s/'95 as 1AA foes. LY (1st mtg w/both having FBS status) GS won 42-10 (-25) with dominating 461-154 yd & 28-9 FD edges (both yds/FD all'd def ssn bests). GS is off a bye & 2W ago became bowl eligible w/a 37-13 (-21) win vs TXST (534-213 yd & 22-13 FD edges). RB Breida ran for a ssn high 205 (8.9) yds & 2 td's as the Eagles finished w/over 500 rush yds for the 2nd time in their L/3 gms! They all'd ssn lows in FD's (13) & yds (213), which was also the Bobcats ssn low (240 yds below avg)! Troy is off their best performance of the ssn in a 51-14 (-9) win over ULM. Troy outgd' ULM 493-276 and set a ssn high in yds. The Trojans were +6 TO's incl IR & FR td's. GS is -26 ypg away, but +149 ypg in SBC action. Troy is -22 ypg but are +69 ypg in their L/4. Versus four common foes, Troy is +19 ppg and +69 ypg while GSU is +14 ypg and +106 ypg. Troy is 6-16 ATS in SBC home gms.

**NEVADA by 7 over San Jose St** - Home finale for UN & they've lost 3 str in that role but are 5-2 ATS. These former WAC rivals are now MW members. UN is 11-1 SU incl 6 str wins (4-2 ATS) in this series. LY UN won 21-10 (-5) but was outgd' 446-256 & outFD'd 24-16. They were +3 TO's incl a 4Q 27-17 IR td. LTH UN only led 21-16 at HT but got the outright upset 38-16 (+7). UN is off a 30-16 (-4) win on the road at FS last Thurs. UN led 17-16 at HT but pitched a shutout in the 2H, all'g just 73 yds & held a 23-23-6/37 TOP edge (498-280 yd). They are +32 ypg in the incl IR & +94 ypg in MW action. SJSU nearly pulled off the outright upset in their 17-16 (+13) home loss to BYU last Fri. SJSU went 85/10pl & scored a td w/:45 left, but their 2 pt conv fell inc. RB Ervin followed up his 263 rush yd effort 2W ago with just 80 (3.5), but the Spartans D continues to be their strength as they held BYU to their 2nd lowest tll yds of the ssn. Big gm for both schls with bowl implications on the line. UN is 4-7 ATS at home, but SJSU is 2-10 as a dog incl 1-8 as an AD.

**Appalachian St by 17 over IDAHO** - LY was the schools only prior mtg. App St won 45-28 (-17) w/430-365 yd & 23-18 FD edges. This is App St's 1st trip to the Kibbie Dome. App St has 2 extra days rest as they are off a Thurs night 40-27 (-10) upset loss vs ASU. App St was up 21-14 early 2Q but all'd 26 unanswered until a td w/3:36 left (outgd' 517-465 & outFD'd 24-18). QB Lamb threw for a ssn high 321 yds & tied his car high w/4 td passes. RB Cox was held to a ssn low 74 rush yds. ID jumped out to a 24-0 lead LW in their 52-45 (+9) loss vs South Alabama but all'd 28 str pts incl a KR td, a FR td and was outscored 52-14 until adding a late td which gave Vandals backers a backdoor cover. ID is -58 ypg on the ssn but are +29 ypg at home. App St is +152 ypg on the ssn and +202 on the road. ID has all'd 266 (6.5) rush ypg while App St avg's 257 (5.5 rush ypg). ID is 12-20 as a HD & 8-15 as a conf HD, while App St is 6-1 ATS away & 8-3 ATS vs SBC foes.

**COLORADO ST by 8 over Univ** - The Rams are 14-3 SU & the home tm is 5-0 SU/ATS. In the L/mtg ('12, also LTH) CSU won 33-11 (+1) leading 24-0 at HT. CSU has won 3 str home finales & 4 str ATS. UNLV won vs Hawaii LW 42-21 (-9). UNLV led 17-14 in the 3Q but pulled away with 2 late tds. UNLV outgd' UH 547-378 & outFD'd them 22-16. UNLV's offense had their highest output vs an FBS foe on the ssn while their defense all'd 69 yds less than they have avg'd. LW CSU won 26-7 (-9) at Wyoming. RB Dawkins ,who played for ir/d RB Oden Jr. (CS), had a car high 25-140 (5.6). CSU's run D has all'd 205 ypg (4.8) on the ssn. UNLV avg's 209 rush ypg but that number drops to 170 rush ypg vs FBS foes. CSU is on a 25-13-1 ATS run, but UNLV is 11-4 ATS away & 13-4 as an AD.

**LOUISVILLE by 11 over Virginia** - Just the 2nd mtg s/'89. LY in their 1st ACC matchup UVA upset #21 UL 23-21 (+5) w/a slight 285-282 yd edge (-4 FD). UVA kicked a 42-yd gm deciding fg w/3:42 off a UL fmbL. UL is coming off a 41-17 win over Syracuse (-14). UL outgd' Cuse 579-286 & outFD'd them 23-13. The 579 yds was a ssn high for UL and the most Cuse's defense has all'd all ssn. HC Petrino decided to go with QB Bolin (24-35-362-3-1) and the move paid off. LW UVA lost at Miami, FL, 27-21 (+5). The Cavs were outgd' 429-407 but outFD'd UM 24-18. UL is +149 ypg at home and +79 ypg in ACC play. UVA is -9 ypg on the road and -14 ypg in ACC play. Big gm for UL's bowl hopes as they need 1 win to be bowl eligible but finish the ssn with B2B road gms. UVA will be ineligible for a bowl with their next loss. UL is 0-7 ATS in home finales. UL is 16-28 as a HF, while UVA is 12-4 as a dog.

**Utah by 10 over ARIZONA** - Wildcats are 3-0 SU/ATS (+98 ypg). LY #15 UA pulled the outright upset 42-10 (+4) over #20 Utah w/a 520-384 yd edge (+1 FD). LTH UA won 35-24 (-3) w/a 468-329 yd edge (+10 FD). UA has now dropped 3 str after a 38-30 loss at USC (+19). UA led USC 20-17 in the 4Q but the Trojans surged ahead 38-23 before UA tacked on a very late td. QB Solomon had his best performance of the ssn (31-46-352-3-1). UA was outgd' 472-412 but outFD'd USC 24-23. Utah is coming off a 34-23 (+2) win at Washington. Utah hadn't forced any TO's in their L/2 gms but forced 4 key TO's that led to 17 pts incl a FR td. Utah was outgd' 381-346 & outFD'd 20-19. The Utes also had 3 TO's of their own. Utah has been outgd' in 4 of their wins this ssn and are just +18 ypg on the ssn. UA is +47 ypg but they are -115 ypg in their L/3. The 'Zona D has all'd foes to gain 53 ypg more than they avg on the ssn which is 111th in FBS. Wildcats are 2-0 SU/ATS in home finales & 3-1 SU/ATS not involving instate rival ASU. AZ is on a 3-8 ATS run, while Utah is 2-5 as an AF and 8-2 ATS on the road.

**TENNESSEE by 35 over North Texas** - Homecoming. NT beat UT 21-14 in their only prior mtg but that was in '75. The Vols are coming off a closer than expected win over SC, 27-24 (-17). UT jumped out to a 17-0 lead but needed a FR to stop SC's final drive. LW NT was blown out by LT 56-13 (+29). The Mean Green were down 49-0 before getting their first td. NT was outgd' 573-316 & outFD'd 25-20. On the ssn, NT has all'd 255 rush ypg (5.8) while UT avg's 207 rush ypg (4.5) and have faced a much tougher schedule. NT is -194 ypg on the ssn and -269 ypg in non conf action. UT is 1-4 as a non conf fav of 14+ pts, but NT is 1-10 as an AD.

**Florida by 7 over SOUTH CAROLINA** - SC is 4-1 SU/4-2 ATS (UF had won 18 of 19 from 1964-'09). LY SC pulled the outright upset 23-20 (+7) in OT w/a 301-289 yd edge (FD's even). LTH #11 SC trailed 14-6 at HT but eventually won 19-14 (-13). Florida clinched the SEC east vs Vandy in a 9-7 (-20) win. UF outgd' Vandy 258-175. The 258 tll yds was their 2nd lowest output of the ssn but they only all'd 175 yds, their lowest output of the ssn. UF trailed 9-7 late in the 4Q but got a GW fg and a SOD. UF held Vandy's struggling offense to just 30 yds passing and the only td all'd was on a broken 74 yd run at the end of the 1H. SC is coming off a strong performance in a 27-24 (+17) loss at Tenn. SC trailed 17-0 late in the 2Q but surged back and was driving late in the 4Q to win but fmbld at the UT 18. SC outgd' UT 257-143 in the 2H. SC is -61 ypg on the ssn and -96 ypg in SEC action. UF is +78 ypg at home and +44 ypg on the road. These two have 6 common foes. UF is 5-1 SU/ATS and are +7 ypg and +40 ypg. SC is 1-5 SU/2-4 ATS and -11 ypg & -96 ypg. SC is 5-0 as a HD, but UF is 7-2-1 vs SEC foes & HC McElwain is on a 27-10-1 ATS run. SC is now 3-0 ATS under Interim HC Elliott.

**STANFORD by 14 over Oregon** - UO is 10-3 SU. Home tm has covered L/2Y. LY #5 UO won 45-16 (-7) w/a 525-428 yd & 30-24 FD edge. LTH #6 SU got the outright upset 26-20 (+10) over #2 UO. Cardinal did lead 17-0 at HT. L/mtg UO came into this gm unranked and SU was ranked was in '97, #20 SU won 58-49 (-8). LW SU won easily over Colorado 42-10 (-16). The Cardinals were led by RB McCaffrey who had his 7th str 100 yd gm (23-147), which tied RB Gerhart for the schl rec. McCaffrey also added to his Heisman campaign with his 1st passing td. SU outgd' CU 472-231 & outFD'd them 25-15. UO won their 3rd str gm with a win over Cal 44-28 (-4). The Ducks had a ssn high 777 yds which was 127 yds more than Cal had all'd all ssn. UO's pass D (mkt'd #81 in our pass efficiency ratings) held QB Goff to just 44% comp. RB Freeman tied his car high going 29-180. The score could have been more lopsided but QB Adams threw 2 int's in the EZ and UO had 2 punts blocked. UO's O avg's 126 ypg more than their foes have all'd on the ssn but SU's D holds their foes to 81 ypg less than they avg. Stanford is +187 ypg at home. The Ducks are +22 ypg on the road. **BOISE ST by 38 over New Mexico** - Boise St has the large edge of having a bye last week and Air Force on deck so their full concentration over the 3 week span is on defending the option. Boise is 6-0 SU but has lost all 4 MW mtg's ATS w/an avg line -32'. LY NM led 42-35 at HT w/a 425-426 yd edge. BSU would eventually win 60-49 (-19) but the Lobos amassed a ssn high 627 yds (BSU had 658). LTH NM lost 45-17 (-37) but only trailed 21-7 at HT covering the entire gm (held BU to 79 yds under their home avg). BSU 2W ago won 55-27 (-20) on the road at UNLV. The Broncos led just 34-27, 4Q, but scored 3 tds in the final 10 min to blow the gm open. QB Rypien threw for a car high 469 yds & is avg 291 pass ypg, compl 66% w/a 12-4 ratio. His fav target WR Sperbeck had a ssn high 10 rec & RB McNichols ran for over 100 yds in his 4th str gm. BSU finished with ssn highs in yds (705) & FD's (34), but also all'd ssn highs in both yds (487) & FD's (28). NM is off an upset win over Utah St, 14-13 (+16). NM was held to a ssn low 236 yds but the NM D only all'd 294 yds, their lowest output of the ssn versus an FBS foe. The Broncos are +257 ypg at home & +225 in MW action. The Lobos are -140 ypg on the road and -97 in MW action being outgd' in their L/4. Boise is 11-19 as a HF & NM is 10-5-1 ATS away.

**IOWA by 14 over Minnesota** - 109th Floyd of Rosedale. Iowa is 10-4 SU & the Visitor is just 1-5 ATS. LY Minn won 51-14 (-1), led 35-7 at HT w/429-205 yd & 23-13 FD edges. LTH ('12) Iowa won 31-13 (-6) leading 24-0 at HT. Iowa continued its undefeated ssn by beating Indiana 35-27 (-7). Iowa led 35-20 in the 4Q. Indiana got a late td to get within a td but Iowa recovered the outside and ran the clock out. Iowa got a gutsy performance from QB Beathard who is battling mult inj's (19-31-233-1) and is the only QB in schl history to win his first 10 starts. QB King got his 8th INT of the ssn, tying the schl rec. Minn is coming off another hard fought loss to a ranked tm, 28-14 (+22) at OSU. Minn trailed 21-14 in the 4Q before all'g a late td run. Minn was outgd' 376-314 & outFD'd 18-13. This is Minn's 3rd str gm vs a top 15 opp incl B2B road gms. The Gophers D has held foes to 91 ypg less than they avg on the ssn. Iowa is +111 ypg on the ssn and +116 ypg at home. Iowa is 8-16 as a HF & Minn is 12-5 as a dog, 7-1 ATS off a SU reg ssn loss & 8-2 ATS in B10 away gms.

**4★ Minnesota over OAKLAND** - MIN continues to deliver on a weekly basis following a 3rd straight 4★ Newsletter Winner and 4th consec LP Winner (3.5★) LW against the Rams. Things weren't easy in MIN's 7th straight home victory however as they did need a FG on the final play for a 2nd straight wk (this time in OT) while also losing QB Bridgewater to an apparent 2H concussion in the process (CS here). They now head to the "Black Hole" to take on an OAK squad (MIN 14-3 ATS vs NDIV foes) that has surprised many so far in '15 with their 4-4 mark (35 ppg, 434 ypg in L/3 gms since their bye) although they are off of a loss LW against PIT, a gm in which they all'd a franchise-worst 597 yds and turned the ball over on 4 occasions. Despite outright upset wins in 2 of their L/3 home contests incl a 14 pt victory (+3) over the Jets 2 wks ago, OAK remains just 22-36-1 as a HD and could find themselves in a tough spot here as they have a pair of away gms on deck while still being tasked in stopping one of the hotter tms in the NFL as MIN has covered an amazing 15 of their L/18 contests. We'll continue to ride with the surging Vikings here w/a 4th consec Top Play 4★ selection as they are now tied atop the NFC North standings at 6-2 on the ssn! **FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 7**

**3★ GREEN BAY over Detroit** - Despite a furious 4Q comeback a week ago against undefeated CAR (trailed 37-14 early 4Q, inside the 5 trailing by 8 with under 2 min remaining), the Packers dropped their 2nd straight game with Rodgers (369 yds, 4 TD) under center for the 1st time s/'10. GB now returns home boasting a 14-7 ATS mark to take on a Lions squad that desperately was in need of a bye following their no-show performance in London (45-10 defeat). While DET is 7-3 ATS following a wk's rest, their 1-10 ATS run has to be a concern heading into this one not to mention their 24-game losing streak in Wisconsin (12 pt avg loss). The Packers meanwhile have had vast success in their NFC North battles over recent years with a 37-18 ATS mark which should allow them to cover this large of a spread in their only HG over a 5-wk span. **FORECAST: GREEN BAY by 17**

## OTHER SELECTION

**2★ DENVER over Kansas City** - The Chiefs return from their bye week sporting a 2-gm winning streak that saw them outscore their opponents by a 68-26 clip. They now head to Denver seeking revenge from a Broncos tm that literally stole away a Wk 2 win at Arrowhead with a pair of TD's in the final :36 of the game including a GW scoop & score 21 yd FR as KC was attempting to run out the clock for OT. An early 17-0 deficit along with a few head-scratching defensive penalties in the 4Q ended up being too much for the undefeated Broncos LW in their 27-24 defeat against QB Manning's former squad (DEN offense a little out of character with 36 passes and just 14 rush att). Despite the loss, this is a good spot for DEN as far as trends are concerned as they have gone 18-8 ATS at home while displaying an even more impressive mark against DIV foes (16-4 ATS). With the continued presence of the NFL's #1 defense (17.4 ppg, 274 ypg), we see no reason why they can't improve on their 8-2 ATS record following a SU loss in this one. **FORECAST: DENVER by 10**

## OTHER GAMES

**Buffalo at NY JETS - TNF** - This matchup got a lot more interesting this offssn with former Jets HC Ryan (46-50 in 6 yrs) moving up North to coach the rival Bills. BUF returned LW from a much needed bye wk (plenty of key offensive inj's) to knock off the Dolphins for the 2nd time TY, a gm in which they fell just short of their ssn-best yardage tll w/420 yds (79 ypg above ssn avg) while winning a HG for the 1st time in their L/4 chances. The Jets meanwhile were fortunate to get back into the win column (outgained 436-290) after a pair of losses as they forced 4 JAX TO's in the 5 pt win (3rd game TY w/a +4 TO margin). With a pair of defensive-minded HC's roaming the sidelines in this one, offense could potentially be at a premium in this projected slugfest. **Dallas by 3 over TAMPA BAY** - The Cowboys continue to search for their 1st victory since the inj to QB Romo as they've now dropped 6 straight (1-5 ATS) incl LW at home against a rested Eagles squad that was seeking revenge from their 10 pt loss to DAL at home in Wk 2 (all'd 33 pts & 459 yds in the OT defeat). The Bucs meanwhile have been a solid surprise over the past few wks with an OT win at Atlanta as a 7 pt dog and a closer than the final score performance against the Giants (NY 9 pts in the final :28, TB 385-327 yd edge). This is a rare situation for TB in this matchup as they are just 5-14-1 ATS as a NDIV HF. On the other hand, DAL has delivered well away from home w/a solid 8-3 ATS road record. With the return of Romo likely to happen a week from now, we expect DAL to leave w/a victory and some much needed momentum.

**Carolina by 7 over TENNESSEE** - Despite being a HD last wk against the Packers (+2), the Panthers were able to keep their 12-gm regular ssn win streak intact. They did nearly blow a 23-pt 4Q lead in the process however as GB had the ball inside the 5 with less than 2 min remaining and trailing by just 8 (QB Newton 4 tll TD's, CAR 427-402 yd edge). They now head on to Nashville to take on a Titans tm that delivered one of the bigger upsets of the ssn (+7) in OT against the Saints behind interim HC Mularkey and QB Mariota who threw for 371 yds and 4 TD's in his 1st gm back from inj (out previous 2 w/knee). While they were able to win for the 1st time since the opener and boast a pretty tough defense (329 ypg all'd, #6 NFL), this is an extremely rough situation for TEN as they have gone just 7-15-2 ATS as a dog and haven't won at home since October of '14 (9 straight defeats). With a potentially winnable TNF matchup at JAX on deck following this one, the Titans could pack it in early against an undefeated CAR squad that is in full control of the conf (every other tm in the NFC has at least 2 losses).

**ST LOUIS by 7 over Chicago** - CHI heads into the dome on a short wk following MNF in San Diego to take on a Rams squad fresh off of their defeat at the hands of the Vikings, a gm in which they outgained MIN by a 320-293 clip but were forced to settle for 4 FG's by Zuerlein (incl 61 yarder & the game-tying 53 yarder to force OT). While STL has been hit or miss on the ssn, they are still very much alive in the NFC playoff race with a 4-4 overall mark. CHI meanwhile has gone just 10-18 ATS as a dog and are clearly shorthanded yet again with numerous inj concerns on the off side of the ball. While we'll go ahead and give the Rams a 7 pt MOV in this matchup, Vegas will decide which way we lean as there is no official line as of presstime.

**New Orleans by 6 over WASHINGTON** - The Saints saw their 3-game winning streak come to an end LW at home against a Titans squad that earned their first win since Wk 1 of the ssn (NO blew 21-10 lead, all'd 483 yds). They now take on a Redskins squad that was hammered by the Patriots in Foxboro following their bye thanks to 7 dropped passes and just 250 yds of tll offense (only TD w/25 left in 4Q). While WAS has been clearly a stronger team at home with 3 straight wins and outgaining foes by 57 ypg, they have struggled mightily as a dog with just a 9-20 ATS mark. The Saints meanwhile have a bye of their own on deck (6-3-1 ATS prior) and more than enough firepower (#2 tll offense at 422 ypg) to get out of D.C. with a victory.

**PHILADELPHIA by 7 over Miami** - The Eagles were able to get some much needed revenge LW at "Jerry World" against the Cowboys thanks in part to a 67 yd IRT TD and a 41-yd TD pass in OT (459 tll yds, +106 over ssn avg). They now head home to take on a Dolphins squad that has now dropped 2 straight contests under interim HC Campbell (won 1st 2) as they were unable to get their own version of payback losing to the Bills for the 2nd time in '15 (MIA now 0-4 vs the AFC East being outscored by a 34-13 avg). While MIA has historically been impressive as an AD (31-18-1 ATS), the Eagles should be able to take care of the Dolphins in this one as they have an even hotter hand with a 7-1 ATS mark as a NDIV HF.

**HAWAII by 3 over Fresno St** - UH has dropped 4 str but has covered the L2Y. LY UH trailed 28-0 at HT (outgd 280-65) but got the backdoor cover on a 12 pt pass w/45 left, lost 28-21 (+10). LTH #25 FSU led 42-3 w/6:11 3Q but all'd 34 unanswered holding on for a 42-37 (-17) win. UH had a 530-431 yd & 31-21 FD edge. FS has 2 extra days rest but do travel to the island. FS is off a Thur Night loss vs UN 30-16 (+4). Bulldogs trailed just 17-16 at HT but in the 2H were shutout, held to 73 yds & had the ball for just 6:37 (outgd 498-280 for gm, 6th time they've been outgd by 200+ yds). FS is -296 ypg away & -214 ypg in MW action. This is the 1st HG for the Rainbow Warriors s/letting HC Chow go. UH is off a 42-21 loss to UNLV (+9). **PITTSBURGH by 10 over Cleveland** - This series has been as one-sided as it can possibly get dating back to 2001 as the Steelers have won 25 of their 29 matchups against the Browns including 11 straight at home (14 pt avg MOV). After suffering B2B losses for the 1st time since Wks 13 & 14 of the '13 ssn, the Steelers rebounded with a 38-35 win over OAK (597 tll yds) behind career days from WR Brown (17 rec, 284 yds) and bkp RB Williams (170 yds, 2 TD). They did however lose QB Roethlisberger (334 yds, 2 TD) again in the process (out w/foot inj) turning the duties over to Landry Jones (2nd car start, 1st at home) who flourished late on the GW drive against the Raiders. While CLE does come in with some extra rest following their TNF matchup w/CIN, their results could have clearly been better as they were able to muster just 2 FD's in the 2H in their 31-10 loss to the Bengals behind QB Manziel and his 15-33 passing performance (QB McCown probable here). Both tms do head to their respective bye wks following this meeting although the Steelers are clearly in the middle of playoff contention and need to continue their momentum here while CLE appears to be going thru the motions once again as a turnaround this late in the ssn seems a little far-fetched.

**BALTIMORE by 3 over Jacksonville** - After 6 losses on the ssn that were decided by just 30 pts, the Ravens were able to get back into the win column 2 wks ago against the Chargers thanks in part to 5 FG's by K Tucker incl the GW 39-yarder on the final play. BAL has been solid off of a bye the past decade with an 8-2 ATS mark while their 26-14-1 ATS record as a NDIV HF has been equally impressive. They now take on a Jaguars squad that blew numerous chances last week against the Jets in a 5 pt loss as while they did finish w/a 436-290 yd edge, a 4-0 TO deficit did them in (incl 3 in the 4Q). While teams have generally faired well against the struggling AFC South the past few years, it's interesting to note that the Ravens have gone just 3-7 ATS in those specific matchups. Despite a TNF matchup vs the Titans on deck, the Jags should be able to stay within the line against a BAL team that's on a 1-9-1 ATS run.

**New England by 10 over NY Giants** - NE heads to East Rutherford (NFL-best 44-10 SU mark against the NFC East s/'02) to take on the Giants for the 1st time since their ssn-ending '07 matchup, a game in which the Patriots narrowly escaped with a 38-35 (-13) win to finish with just the 2nd perfect regular ssn in the Super Bowl era (later lost to the Giants in the SB). The NFL's #1 scoring offense (34.5 ppg, scored in 31 consec quarters) moved their ATS mark against NDIV foes to an impressive 15-4-1 LW against the Redskins while delivering a 3★ LP Winner in the process (only WAS TD came w/25 remaining). Despite a 385-327 yd deficit, the Giants were able to go into TB and take away a 32-18 victory thanks in part to 3 TO's by the hometown Bucs. While the Giants head into their bye week following this contest, the edge still goes to a Patriots team that appears to be somewhat reminiscent of the magical '07 squad, which is also coincidentally the last time they were undefeated this late in the ssn.

**Arizona at SEATTLE - SNF** - Huge opportunity for both teams coming off of their bye weeks as the Seahawks need a win to stay within reach of the division while a victory here by the visiting Cardinals could give them 3-game lead over the 2-time Defending NFC Champs. Despite finding themselves in the Top 3 in both scoring (17.5) and tll defense (285 ypg), the SEA offense has been the main culprit for their lack of success as they are DEAD LAST in the NFL w/31 sks all'd while scoring a total of just 12 offensive TD's thru 8 gms. The Cardinals meanwhile have scored 28 offensive TD's over that same span (#2 scoring offense, 32.9 ppg) while also finding themselves in the Top 10 in scoring defense (19.1 ppg). Something will have to give in this primetime matchup as the Cardinals have seen solid success on the road recently with a 14-6 ATS mark while the Seahawks are 9-4-1 ATS vs the NFC West (4-1 ATS run vs ARZ) and have the "12th Man" behind them in this one. **Houston at CINCINNATI - MNF** - Despite just a 3-5 overall mark, the Texans have actually been able to outgain their opponents by 18 ypg on the ssn. They now return from their bye week with a chance to tie the idle Colts for 1st place in the AFC South following IND's 27-24 upset win over the undefeated Broncos. The Bengals also have some extra rest coming in after their 21 pt win over the Browns on TNF, a game in which they surrendered just 2 FD's the entire 2H (371-213 yardage edge) while also moving their ATS mark to 7-0-1 on the year.
