Aub is 7-1 ATS TY after winning our **5★ Oct GOM LW** over Ole Miss! They got the return of RB Johnson, but it was once again Pettway leading the ground gm w/his 3rd straight gm over 100 as he finished w/a car high 236 (7.9)! VU is all'g 207 (5.0) rush ypg away so look for the Tigers option like rush attack to again perform at a high level. **FORECAST: AUBURN by 35**

3★ KANSAS ST over Oklahoma St - As large an edge as OSU has on OFF, KSt has an equally large edge on D & the Wildcats are home. QB Ertz is off his first 100 yd effort of the ssn & the Pokes are all'g 209 (5.2) rush ypg vs B12 foes. OSU QB Rudolph is having a phenomenal yr w/a 17-2 ratio & despite KSt having a large edge on D, they rate just #87 in our pass eff D rankings. The Wildcats won the L/2 mtgs here by 34 & 14 pts. The Pokes win vs WV not as good as final score indicates as they were outFD'd by 10 & outgd' by 63. KSt is 44-20 ATS vs the B12. **FORECAST: KANSAS ST by 10**

Cincy is 8-4 as a HD & BYU has our #89 ranked pass eff D so look for Kiel to rebound at home. **FORECAST: Byu by 4**

2★† Notre Dame over Navy - Gm being ply'd in Jacksonville. Despite the loss LW, Navy's OFF continues to roll along as the ssn progresses, avg 45 ppg their L/3 gms. ND's D came under fire earlier TY so they fired their DC & is all'g just 267 ypg their L/3 gms. While the Middies OFF is in high gear, their leaky D is surrendering 436 ypg & has our #121 pass eff D & Irish QB Kizer had his confidence re-newed after throwing his 1st td passes in almost a month LW vs Miami. ND is 7-3 ATS in this series on a neutral field & was 2-0 vs the option LY. **FORECAST: Notre Dame by 13**

Toledo at AKRON - Both are off disappointing losses LW as neither no longer control their own fate in reaching the MAC Title gm. TU trying to win here for the 1sts time s/98. While UA lost their last HG 41-0 vs WM, they were w/o QB Woodson & he's ply'd their L/2 gms. Rocket RB's Swanson & Hunt have been held under 100 yds each of the L/2 wks & the Zips are all'g 251 (5.8) rush in MACtion. UA is 7-19 as a HD, while TU is 4-1 as an AF.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 3 Call 7Pk/VIP tape for Your Marquee Winner at noon ET!
Buffalo at OHIO - OU controls its own destiny in the MAC East & has won 5 of 6, while UB snapped its 4 gm skid defeating Akron LW, which helped the Bobcats quest. UB RB Johnson set a schl rec w/282 rush yds LW, but OU is all'g just 104 (2.9) rush in MACtion. OU hasn't won by more than 16 pts TY & than includes an FCS foe. The HT is 12-6 ATS in the series, but the dog is 8-2 ATS in OU gms.

Arkansas St at GEORGIA ST - While ArkSt continues its ascension up the SBC ranks, GSt continues its descension down them. The RedWolves don't have to rely on just their rush attack as QB Hansen threw for 300+ yds & a car high 4 td passes LW. GSt OFF continues to be stuck in neutral especially under QB Winchester w/B2B gms under 300 yds. Manning remains a ? to return. ArkSt 3-0 as an AF, but 1st time in that role TY, while Panthers are on a 12-3-1 overall ATS run. Can GSt repeat same results as LY (also 2-6 before winning 4 straight & getting a bowl bid)?

Oklahoma at IOWA ST - OU showing why it was the pick to make the playoffs before the ssn began as they remain unbeaten in B12 play, while ISt enters winless in the conf & losers of 4 str. The matchup here is simple. The Sooners run a balanced OFF, while the Cycones struggle against the run, which bodes trouble as RB Mixon leads a rush attack that is avg 251 (5.9) rush ypg in conf play. OU is 9-3 ATS in the series, but ISt pulled an outright upset on a tm from OK on a Thurs night in '11 (Okla St).

Ucla at COLORADO - QB Rosen should return after missing the L/2 (CS). Both enter fresh off byes. CU RB Lindsay has two 100+ yd efforts & they've come in the L/2 gms, but UCLA all'g 100 (3.0) rush ypg away. UCLA has lost by more than 7 just once & that was vs Stan due to a FR td at the end. Bufts 3-0 ATS in the series & 8-0 ATS TY, while UCLA 1-3 as an AD.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 4 Call 7Pk/VIP tape for Your Marquee Winner at noon ET!
Central Michigan at MIAMI, OH - No, don't take a double take when looking at the MAC standings that show MU with a better record than CM. The Redhawks have won 3

straight due to a D that is holding their conf foes to 87 ypg below their ssn avg. CM is no slouch on D either though, holding their conf opp's to an even better 96 ypg below their avg. CM is 5-2 ATS in the series & 13-4 ATS on the road, while MU is 3-8 ATS in conf HG's. CM is on its 3rd AG in 4 wks.

Temple at CONNECTICUT - TU is one of the lesser talked about hottest tms in the nation, having won 5 of 6 incl 3 straight. QB Walker began the ssn slowly, but has a 5-1 ratio over his L/3 gms, while the RB duo of Armstead & Thomas have comb'd for 676 rush yds in that same span. The Owls however are ply'g a 10th str wk & are just 1-2 on the road, with their win coming w/:01 left after trailing 25-7. UConn's once stout D reeling lately all'g 430+ yds in 4 of L/6 gms. TU is on a 7-0 ATS run TY, while the visitor in this series is 6-3 ATS w/3 outright upsets the L5Y.

San Jose St at BOISE ST - Boise enters after having their bubble burst so look for an angry bunch here against an overmatched SJSt squad. QB Rypien failed to throw a td pass for the 1st time TY, but he'll get back on track here as the Spartans counter with our #115 pass eff D. While opponents haven't been as intimidated on the Blue turf of late, SJSt is just -29 ppg & -174 ypg on the road. Boise is 7-3 ATS in the series & has won 12 in a row SU. The Broncos are also 9-3 ATS off a SU loss.

SATURDAY NOV 5

APPALACHIAN ST by 38 over Texas St - AppSt could be the best in the SBC, while there's no doubt that TXSt is the worst in the conf. The Mountaineers got the return of RB Cox LW after missing nearly 5 full gms & he along w/RB Moore comb'd for 241 rush (7.3) & the Bobcats are all'g 243 (4.6) rush ypg in SBC action. Against 2 mutual foes (ULL & GSt) AppSt was +38 pts & +225 yds, while TXSt was -44 pts & -296 yds. Mountaineers are 10-2 ATS on the road in the reg ssn, while the Bobcats are 1-7 as a DD dog.

ARMY by 1 over Air Force - An AF win will award them the Commander-In-Chief trophy as they've already beaten Navy earlier TY. Army won't make it easy as they're off to their best start s/2010 (also last yr bowling). The Falcons haven't been the same since beating Navy, but they did snap a 3 gm slide LW at Fresno. With both option OFF's hitting on all cylinders in the run gm, this could come down to QB play & AF's Romine was inj LW (CS) & bkp Worthman came on in relief & didn't attempt a pass, but did run for over 100, while Army's Bradshaw just went 6-8-145, leading the win at WF LW. AF is 8-1 SU/ATS at Army, but they're on the 2nd of B2B AG's & are just 4-9 as an AF.

Louisville by 24 over BOSTON COLLEGE - This gm comes down to this. Sure, BC has a great D, but L'Ville has an even greater OFF & when the Cards jump out to a big lead, the Eagles don't have the OFF to play catch up. L'Ville survived a scare LW, but QB Jackson had another 'Heisman Moment' throwing the GW td w/:13 left. BC has already lost by 49 at VT & 46 vs Clemson here. The Eagles are 2-9 ATS at home. This is the 2nd of B2B AG's for the Cards.

MINNESOTA by 21 over Purdue - Both trending in opposite directions. Against MD, both were dogs, but UM won 31-10, while PU lost 50-7. Against the 3 other common foes (PSU, IL, IO) Gophers are +4 ppg & -17 ypg, while Boilermakers are -16 ppg & -75 ypg. The is PU's 4th AG in 6 wks & look for UM RB Smith to rush for 100+ in his 4th straight game. The HT is 7-4 ATS in this series & UM is fully capable of winning by over 2 td's.

Virginia Tech by 10 over DUKE - VT controls its own fate in reaching the ACC Title gm after beating Pitt last Thurs. QB Evans is off a car high 406 yd effort & has a sensational 21-2 ratio TY! Blue Devils counter w/a D that has 23 sks (11.0%) & rates #55 in our pass eff D rankings, all'g 50.2% completions. This is VT's 4th AG in 5 wks, while Duke had a bye 2 wks ago. The last time Hokies were a DD road fav they lost outright to Syr. Blue Devils are 10-5 as an ACC HD, while VT is 4-10 as an AF.

CLEMSON by 24 over Syracuse - CU survived its trip to Tallahassee LW & it should be smooth sailing from here to the playoffs, however 'Not so fast my friend,' as the Tigers have won 6 of their 8 FBS gms by just 7.8 ppg! QB Watson is off his best gm of the ssn, compl 75% & his 20-8 ratio matches up well against our #59 ranked pass eff D, but keep in mind Syr is fresh off a bye, while Tigers just gave max effort. CU is 3-6 as a conf fav of 20+, while Orange are 4-0 as a 20+ pt dog.

WEST VIRGINIA by 35 over Kansas - How will WV respond after having their bubble burst? They ply'd well enough to win in Stillwater, but TO's killed them. Meanwhile KU home/away dichotomy is startling as they're +41 ypg home, but -252 ypg away & this is their 3rd AG in 4 wks & 2nd straight. WV doesn't have your typical B12 D & the Jayhawks have arguably the worst OFF in the nation. WV is in a OSU/TX sandwich & HC Holgersen is 0-5 ATS off a SU loss, while KU is 3-10-1 ATS as a B12 dog. Jayhawks have dropped 42 straight away from Lawrence (2-10 ATS).

Indiana by 13 over RUTGERS - IU in a must win situation to go bowling as they'll be favored in just 1 more gm this ssn. Hoosiers in revenge mode after all'g 25 pt lead slip away LY. IU had three 100 yd rushers LW led by RB Redding & RU is all'g 311 (6.4) rush ypg in B10 play. Hoosiers are 3-0 as an AF, while RU is 4-8 ATS at home. Scarlet Knights are fresh off a bye, while IU ply'g a 7th straight wk, but if they get a big lead again they won't let up like LY.

Michigan St by 4 over ILLINOIS - If MSU loses 1 more gm it will be eliminated from bowl contention. QB play has hurt as they've rotated between O'Connor & Lewerke, but RB Scott has B2B 100 yd efforts & Sparty finished w/the most yds Michigan has all'd in their inspired effort LW. IL has 1 more win than MSU in B10 play but is -121 ypg, while Sparty is -12 ypg. MSU is 5-0 ATS at IL, winning by 23 ppg, but Sparty is 0-5 as an AF & has been outright upset 5 times TY.

Florida St by 11 over NC STATE - FSU AA DB James was sorely missed LW, but he could return TW (CS). The situation favors NCSt in their 2nd str HG, while the Noles off a max effort emotional loss vs Clemson. RB Cook has 4 straight 100+ yd rush gms & while the Wolfpack are all'g just 95 (2.9) rush ypg at home, they're all'g 149 rush ypg their L/3 gms. NCSt is 11-3-1 ATS w/6 outright upsets the L15Y in this series, but Noles are 4-0 ATS off a SU loss incl 2-0 TY. FSU gets their mojo back & should win by DD's.

MICHIGAN by 24 over Maryland - Not even a healthy QB Hills could help MD as they lost their 1st gm of the ssn when he's ply'd the entirety. Both have ply'd MSU with similar results as UM was +9 pts & +35 yds, while MD was +11 pts & +21 yds. Terps HC Durkin was the DC at UM & knows the personnel inside & out. MD RB Johnson has B2B 100 yd efforts & Wolve's run D all'd 217 (5.2) LW. This is a MSU/Iowa sandwich for UM & MD is 12-7 as an AD, while UM is 7-11 ATS off a SU win. We feel that MD keeps this gm closer than expected.

WAKE FOREST by 4 over Virginia - WF had to expect to be bowl elig heading into this gm, but laid an egg LW at home vs Army, while UVA was :13 away from pulling the outright upset vs L'Ville & are 1 loss away from staying home for the holidays. WF QB Wolford has just a 4-7 ratio, but has an excellent shot at having success against our #96 ranked pass eff D that has all'd a 18-8 ratio. The Dog in this series is 5-1 ATS w/4 outright upsets, but the last mtg was in '12.

TULSA by 7 over East Carolina - Expect a high scoring affair as both schls feature potent OFF's that play little D. TU RB Flanders set a schl rec w/5 rush td's (tied AAC mark) while rushing for 249 yds as he & RB Taylor comb'd for 352 rush yds. EC QB Nelson is compl close to 70%, but the Golden Hurricane do rate a solid #30 in our pass eff D rankings (EC comes in #72). EC is 4-2 ATS in the series, but are travelling for the 5th time in 8 wks & are 0-3-1 ATS on the road TY.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 17 over Utsa - MT was in a letdown spot LW at FIU after pulling the outright upset over Mizzou & it showed as they all'd the lowly Panther OFF to finish w/a ssn high in yds. The UTSA RB duo of Williams & Rhodes have been held under 100 yds individually every other gm the L/5, so if that trend continues, 1 should break 100 TW & the Blue Raiders have all'd 279 rush ypg their L/2. The Roadrunners have been a DD dog twice this yr & covered both by 39.5 & 16.5 pts.

SOUTHERN MISS by 17 over Charlotte - SM has been dominant at home TY +323 ypg (+10 ypg away). Both ply'd Marshall in their L/gms & while the Golden Eagles were +248 yds, CU was just +37. The 49ers are fresh off a bye, but SM had a bye 2 wks ago. SM QB Mullens has an 11-2 ratio his L/5 gms (LSU included) & CU has our #104 ranked pass eff D. Despite the dominant stats at home, SM is 0-4 as a HF TY.

BAYLOR by 3 over Tcu - The last time these tms ply'd here the B12 officiating crew cost TCU a win & thus a trip to the playoffs. Baylor had their bubble burst LW per usual after opening their ssn w/easy foes. TCU enters having lost 3 of 4, but their D remains solid, having held both WV & TT to ssn lows in yds in B2B wks. Bears RB Williams is off a ssn high 180 yd effort & QB Russell even had over 100 yds rush & he has a solid 18-5 ratio. TCU is 7-1 ATS in this series. Baylor does have OU on deck. We feel TCU keeps it close.

MIAMI, FL by 10 over Pittsburgh - A Pitt win makes them bowl elig, while UM enters having lost 4 straight. Canes QB Kaaya in a good situation taking on a Panther pass D that has all'd 400+ yds 3 times & rates #101 in our pass eff D rankings. Pitt RB Conner had his 1st 100 yd rush effort s/wk3, but UM is all'g just 100 (2.5) rush ypg at home. UM gets a bit of a sked break here off Fla St, UNC, VT, & ND in B2B2B2B wks! Canes are 7-3 ATS in this series & end their losing streak with a solid win this week.

NORTH CAROLINA by 13 over Georgia Tech - UNC enters fresh off a bye & QB Trubisky is compl over 70% w/an 18-2 ratio & GT enters with our #107 ranked pass eff D. Yellow Jackets will be ply'g w/revenge after blowing a 21 pt lead, but the Tar Heels have had extra time to prep for the option & after all'g 4 of their F/5 foes 200+ rush yds, have held their L/3 (VT, Miami, UVA) to just 3.1 ypc. GT is travelling for just the 2nd time TY & is just 2-11 ATS vs ACC opp's.

Georgia by 3 over KENTUCKY - Both are trending in opposite directions as UGA has lost 4 of 5, while KY has won 5 of 6 incl 3 straight. The Wildcats upswing is due to a power run gm led by the 1-2 punch of RB's Williams & Snell, who each had 180+ in their upset at Mizzou LW. The Bulldogs have held their L/2 foes to ssn lows in yds & are all'g just 99 (2.5) rush ypg. UGA RB's Chubb & Michel have been held under 100 yds each of the L/2 gms, but KY is all'g 206 (4.7) rush ypg at home. UGA has won 6 in a row SU by 21 ppg in this series w/3 straight covers.

Florida by 3 over ARKANSAS - Ark enters off a much needed bye as they've alternated W's & L's their 6 gms, while UF is in the drivers seat in the SEC East, but are off rival UGA. Hogs RB Williams was shutdown his L/gm vs Aub & could find the running lanes just as congested, so QB Allen will need to return to his early ssn form to give them a chance. Sked edge goes to Ark & the Gators are just 4-11 SU vs the SEC West. The Hogs beat Ole Miss earlier TY as a similar HD.

COLORADO ST by 17 over Fresno St - CSU has a solid situational edge, fresh off a bye, while FSt has an interim HC, ply'g a 10 straight wk & 4th AG in 6 wks. Rams QB Hill is OFY, but bkp Stevens has a 4-0 ratio his L/2 starts & FSt has our #93 ranked pass eff D w/an 18-3 ratio. CSU has had just one 100 yd rusher in a gm TY as they utilize 3 RB's, but there's a solid chance they get another as FSt is all'g 283 (5.1) rush in MW action. The Rams are 13-6 as a HF, while the Bulldogs are 1-9 as an AD.

MISSISSIPPI by 28 over Georgia Southern - Ole Miss gets a break after 3 gm gauntlet at Ark, at LSU & vs Aub, but they do have a trip to A&M on deck, while this is the 4th AG in 5 wks for GS. The Landshark D saw the option earlier TY vs FCS Wofford & all'd a respectable 4.1 ypc. Rebels QB Kelly should be able to exploit Eagle's secondary that rates just #83 in our pass eff D rankings. Ole Miss has won their 3 HG's by 35.3 ppg. Rebels are 8-1 ATS as a 14+ fav vs non conf foes, while GS is 1-7 ATS TY & 1-5 as an AD.

TROY by 24 over Massachusetts - Troy is in a great situation off their 2nd bye in 4 wks, while UMass is ply'g a 10th straight wk & travelling for the 2nd time in 3 wks. Troy QB Silvers had a ssn high 395 pass yds his last gm & will look across at a unit that has just our #122 ranked pass eff D, all'g a 17-3 ratio. A win here guarantees a winning ssn for the Men of Troy for the 1st time s/2010. HC Brown is 6-1 ATS vs non conf opp's, while Minutemen are 10-17 as an AD, but keep in mind Troy does have gms vs the 2 main SBC contenders on deck.

RICE by 3 over Florida Atlantic - The pillow fight of the wk belongs to this matchup. These schls were outscored by a comb'd 113-19 LW! Both have 1 win on the ssn vs FCS opp's. Rice RB Stewart had 14 yds in the F/4 gms, but has 348 his L/4, while FAU is all'g 216 (4.7) rush ypg in CUSA play. Conversely FAU RB Howell had his 3 gm 100 yd streak snapped LW, but Rice is all'g 204 (4.9) rush ypg at home. Rice is 11-4-2 as a HF, while FAU is on a 2-7 overall ATS run.

WYOMING by 7 over Utah St - WY HC Bohl got his statement win LW, bursting Boise's bubble as the Pokes now are in control in the Mountain Div. WY is bowl elig for the 1st time s/'11, while UTSt enters having lost 4 of 5. WY RB Hill is one of the most underrated backs in the nation & already is over 1,000 on the ssn, while the Aggies are in an uncomfortable role of facing some of the nations elite RB's over the latter half of their sked (LW all'd SDSSt RB Pumphrey 223, 7.0). UTSt is 5-0 ATS in this series & how will the Pokes respond after their emotional win LW?

SOUTH CAROLINA by 4 over Missouri - Mizzou's D has long been their calling card, especially since entering the SEC, but TY they're once proud unit has led to their downfall as the Tigers are 1 loss away from staying home for the holidays in B2B ssn's for the 1st time s/'02. SC is off 1 of the biggest upsets of the yr, seemingly knocking Tenn out of the SEC East race as QB Bentley, who should still be in HS, is now 2-0 as the st'r w/a 4-0 ratio. Mizzou's D has a chance to get on track for at least 1 wk & their OFF remains potent. There has been 3 outright upsets the L/5 mtgs in this series.

Teams are listed in alphabetical order that pulled the outright upset followed by the line, score, opponent, what they covered by and if they were a Away Dog (AD), Home Dog (HD) or † (neutral site). Also listed is if the game went to OT. The rank number is by what the team covered by, a look below shows Akron's 44.5 pt cover over Marshall as the most a dog has covered by this season so far and SMU's 44 pt cover over Houston & Louisville's 44 pt cover over Florida St tied for #2. Wyoming is the KING of the outright upset this year so far with 4 followed by Eastern Michigan, Hawaii, Miami (OH), North Texas and Syracuse with 3 each. Double Digit outright upsets are in **BOLD**.

Bama is having another typical Bama yr as they have arguably the nations best D & their now uptempo OFF is avg 498 ypg. Against the 1 common foe (Ole Miss) LSU won by 17 & was +190 yds while Bama won by 5 & was -35 yds! An LSU win would result in a 4 way tie in the SEC West Div provided both A&M & Aub win TW. Bama is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in this series, but this gm is basically a toss up. We've already had 4 outright winners for our 'Underdog POW' on these pages & LSU gets the call as we look to improve to 7-2-1 on the yr with this special selection! **FORECAST: Alabama by 3**

South Alabama by 14 over ULM - SA only all'd 14 FD's & 240 yds LW & still only won by a fg thanks to their putrid OFF. Good thing they have ULM this wk as the Warhawks are even worse on D than the Jags are on OFF ULM has our #103 ranked pass eff D & is all'g 275 (6.0) rush ypg which is good news for SA QB Davis, who hasn't thrown for more than a td in a gm s/mid Sept & RB Johnson, whose lone 100 yd effort was vs an FCS foe. SA is 4-0 as an AF, while ULM is 1-4 as a HD. This should start a solid winning streak for the Jags as their L/4 foes have a comb'd 10-22 record.

UL LAFAYETTE by 13 over Idaho - Both are fresh off byes & ULL is 1-5 ATS while ID is 3-0 ATS in that role. The Cajuns had high expectations entering this ssn & have had a disappointing ssn, but still can achieve their goal of getting to a bowl, while the Vandals are also attempting to reach the postssn in their final yr as an FBS member. ULL RB McGuire has been banged up, but had his first 100 yd rush effort in over a month his last gm, while ID is all'g 214 (5.7) rush ypg away. ULL is 2-0 as a HF TY & needs to gain confidence down the stretch.

WKU by 28 over FIU - FIU won their first 3 gms under their interim HC, but have now lost B2B, while WKU enters having won 4 of 5 with 3 straight covers. The Hilltoppers OFF is clicking on all cylinders as QB White has thrown for 300+ yds in 4 straight gms & RB Wales would have easily surpassed 100 rush yds for a 3rd straight gm LW but only had 10 carries (8.6 ypc). WKU defeated ODU in their L/home gm by 35 pts & the Monarchs are better than FIU. The Hilltoppers are 9-4 as a DD fav.

Louisiana Tech by 14 over NORTH TEXAS - LT is hitting its stride at the right time of the yr, having won 5 straight, four by DD's. QB Higgins is quietly having a phenomenal yr, completing close to 70% w/a 26-3 ratio, but NT has our #27 ranked pass eff D so he will be tested. NT RB Wilson had rushed for 348 in 2 gms prior to LW, but was shut down finishing w/just 43 (2.3) at UTSA. He has a good chance to bounce back as LT all'd their most rush yds in over a month LW. LT is on their 3rd AG in 4 wks & NT is 5-3 as a HD.

Washington by 21 over CALIFORNIA - Tough situation for UW off big gm at Utah with ESPN's Colledge Gameday on hand & an upswing USC on deck, while Cal has extra rest following their Thurs loss at the aforementioned Trojans. Huskie pass D will be tested against projected #1DC QB Webb who's thrown for nearly 3,000 yds w/a 29-8 ratio. Can UW D that has 26 sks get pressure on Cal OL that has all'd just 15 (3.6%)? We believe so! Huskie RB Gaskins has rushed for 100+ in 4 straight gms & Bears are all'g 281 (5.7) rush ypg in P12 action. UW is 5-2 ATS in the series & HC Petersen is 25-12 as an AF, while Bear HC Dykes is 4-10 ATS at home vs foes off a SU win.

USC by 24 over Oregon - USC has done a total 180 degree turn after losing 3 of 4 to open the ssn as they enter on a 4 gm winning streak. A big reason is changing QB's to Darnold & he's had B2B gms w/5 td passes & has a 18-3 ratio on the yr. That presents a big prob to a UO secondary that rates just #80 in our pass eff D rankings. RB Ware has B2B 100 yd gms filling in for an inj'd Justin Davis (CS) & the Ducks are poor defending that as well, all'g 274 (5.9) rush ypg in P12 action. UO is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series & the visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS, but USC is 22-11 ATS at home & ply'g w/revenge after getting knocked out of the rankings following LY's loss. The Ducks are also on a 1-8-1 overall ATS run.

OLD DOMINION by 7 over Marshall - ODU is just 1 win away from becoming bowl elig for the 1st time in schl history, while MU is 1 loss away from staying home for the holidays for the 1st time s/'12. They've ply'd 1 common foe in Charlotte & the Monarchs won by 35 & were +127 yds on the road, while the Herd, despite being home, lost by 3 & were outgd'd by 37 yds. MU has won both mtgs in this series by 31 ppg, but are on the 2nd of B2B AG's while ply'g a 9th straight wk & ODU is ply'g at home for the 1st time in 4 wks & will play inspired in front of their home fans.

SAN DIEGO ST by 28 over Hawaii - The nations leading RB is on his way to becoming the all-time leader in the FBS & will pad his stats some more against a porous Haw rush D that is all'g 248 (4.8) rush ypg in conf play. Pumphrey has failed to reach 100 just once & that was the opener vs an FCS foe. Warrior QB Brown failed to throw a td pass for the 1st time as the str & the Aztecs have our #15 ranked pass eff D. SDSt is 4-0 ATS in this series. Haw the L/3 wks has led and/or tied their foes in the 4Q, dropping 2 & may be emotionally spent.

Texas by 7 over TEXAS TECH - Both enter with identical records overall & in B12 play. Against 2 common foes (OU, KST) TT is -6.5 ppg & +257 ypg and TX is -4 ppg & -154 ypg. TT QB Mohomes has a 28-7 ratio & the Horns have just our #112 ranked pass eff D, but to limit possessions look for TX to pound the ball w/RB Foreman, who has 9 str 100 yd rush efforts dating back to LY (car high 250, 7.8 LW). The visitor is 5-2 ATS in this series & the Horns have won 3 in a row SU in Lubbock.

Texas A&M by 10 over MISSISSIPPI ST - A&M followed up having their bubble burst w/a 42 pt non covering win vs SBC NMST, while MSU had more than they could handle against FCS Samford, all'g 627 yds in the process, which was a ssn high! The Bulldogs all'd 468 yds thru the air and A&M QB Knight has yet to throw for 300 vs an FBS schl TY, but has a prime opportunity to do so TW if the running gm isn't going as planned. The tech edges all favor MSU however, as they're 17-10 ATS vs SEC foes, while A&M is 8-19-1 ATS vs the SEC incl 4-10 ATS on the SEC road.

Memphis by 7 over SMU - SMU answered the question of how they would respond after pulling a huge upset as they travelled to Tulane & pulled off a 2nd straight outright upset (although minor) & now find themselves tied with Memphis in the AAC West standings. The Tigers are +59 ypg at home, but -55 ypg away & the Ponies are filled with confidence. Despite completing just over 50% in B2B wks, QB Hicks is improving & getting help from RB West, who has 3 straight 100 yd efforts. The visitor in this series is 5-2 ATS, but UM is 0-3 ATS on the road TY & are travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks.

PENN ST by 3 over Iowa - PSU had a bit of a hangover LW foll'g their outright upset of OSU the wk prior, outscoring PU 45-7 in the 2H. IO is fresh off a bye. While PSU is 5-0 SU at home TY winning by 12 ppg, the road tm in Iowa B10 gms is 5-0 SU, winning each by 7+ pts. Nittany Lion RB Barkley has rushed for 200+ in 2 of his L/3 gms, but the Hawkeyes are all'g just 3.6 ypc in B10 play. Iowa is 15-3 ATS on the road & this gm will likely go down to the wire.

STANFORD by 24 over Oregon St - Stanford made a change at the QB position LW & while they didn't overwhelm on OFF, they still finished w/their most yds in over a month as RB McCaffrey had his first 100 yd rush effort s/3 straight gms to open the ssn. OSU is all'g 239 (5.4) rush ypg in P12 play, so expect McCaffrey to build on that momentum. The Cardinal are 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS in this series & on a 17-8 ATS run, while OSU is on a 10-18 ATS run.

Wisconsin by 7 over NORTHWESTERN - NW had their 3 gm win streak snapped, but gave OSU all they could handle LW, getting outgd'd by just 25 yds. Wisky has ply'd MSU, Mich, OSU, IO, & handed Neb their 1st loss in a 6 wk span (bye before Bucks). The Badgers calling card is on D as they've held 7 of their 8 opp's to either their lowest or 2nd lowest yds tll on the ssn! RB Clement was held in check LW, but his running mate Ogunbowale had his 1st 100 yd effort on just 11 carries. The HT is 8-1 SU/7-1-1 ATS in this series. Badgers ply'g w/revenge after losing as a DD fav in their home finale LY.

OHIO ST by 17 over Nebraska - Neb had their bubble burst LW at Wisc & now have to travel to Columbus. The Buckeyes continue to win unimpressively as they look like the least exp'd tm in the country. QB Barrett is having a solid ssn, despite the youth at the WR position, which is affecting the OFF. The Blackshirts have held 3 straight foes to their 2nd lowest yds tll of the ssn. OSU is home for the 2nd of B2B HG's & has a trip to MD on deck. Neb did allow 223 (5.9) rush vs Wisky LW & OSU RB Weber has been held under 100 yds in 4 straight gms, so look for the rushing lanes to be open. OSU needs a statement win in the worst way & we feel they get that this week.

NEW MEXICO by 15 over Nevada - NV is fresh off a bye, while NM is off a trip to the Is-lands. The Lobos are 1 win away from becoming bowl elig & their triple option OFF is avg 357 (6.8) rush ypg, led by RB Owens, who has 3 straight 100 yd efforts. The Wolfpack are all'g 284 (5.7) rush ypg & all'd option based FCS Cal Poly 383 (5.4) rush. NV is 5-1 ATS off a bye, but are 1-7 ATS TY & NM is on a 16-10 ATS run.

UCF by 16 over Tulane - UCF nearly pulled the outright upset LW at Hou & are now returning home for the 1st of 3 straight HG's (thanks to Hurricane Matthew), while TU has lost 3 straight as they continue to grow into their new option OFF. Knight QB Milton failed to throw a td pass for the 1st time TY in a gm he started & Tulane has our #58 ranked pass eff D, so he should be able to have success this wk. UCF is all'g just 136 (3.3) rush ypg, but has yet to see the option TY. UCF is 5-2 SU/ATS in this series.

TUESDAY NOVEMBER 8TH

Eastern Michigan at BALL ST - Maction on a Tuesday & EM gets another shot at becoming bowl elig for the 1st time s/'95 after losing at home to Miami despite being a td fav. BSU enters off a Tues mtg vs WM that was yet to be ply'd as of this writeup. The Cards are avg 227 (4.9) rush ypg & the Eagles all'd the Redhawks to rush for 230 (5.3) LW. BSU is 10-1 SU/7-4 ATS in the series.

Western Michigan at KENT ST - WM enters off a Tues mtg vs Ball St & is undefeated at presstime. They are the lone Group of 5 tm that is still undefeated. Kent defeated CM last Sat, so will have a couple of extra days to prepare. QB Holley has had B2B gms w/over 100 rush yds. The Flashes are 0-3 ATS vs ranked foes.

4★ Dallas over CLEVELAND - After blowing another lead LW at home against the Jets (led 20-7 at HT) to remain winless on the ssn (CLE 407-393 yd edge), the Browns welcome a red hot Cowboys squad that moved their winning streak to 6 in a row a wk ago against PHI thanks to a strong 4Q that helped them erase a 10 pt deficit and force OT (Top LP 3.5★ Winner on the OVER 43). With DAL having covered each of their L/5 when listed as a NDIV AF and CLE's struggles in their meetings with the NFC (9-18 ATS), the smart money is on the visitor in this one as CLE is still on a 4-14 overall ATS run (given up offensive ssn yardage highs to 3 of their L/4 opp). **FORECAST: DALLAS by 14**

3★ New Orleans over SAN FRANCISCO - Despite no production out of starting RB Ingram (5 rush yds & a fumble) and the Seahawks knocking on the door late trailing by 5, the Saints got it done once again in the Superdome vs SEA (28-15 FD edge by NO). They now head to the Bay Area to take on a 49ers team that's on quite the skid with SU & ATS losses in each of their past 6 gms where they've been outscored by an avg margin of 17 ppg. While the 49ers are still a solid 10-5 ATS as a HD and NO's offense is clearly weaker on the road (23 ppg, 342 ypg) compared to in the Superdome (33 ppg, 470 ypg), the Saints are on a 9-3 ATS run which doesn't bode well for a SF squad that's gone just 2-8-1 ATS following their bye week. **FORECAST: NEW ORLEANS by 10**

2★ GREEN BAY over Indianapolis - Following a 1 pt loss LW in ATL where the Falcons scored the GW TD w/:31 remaining and ruined a nice outing from QB Rodgers (246 pass, 60 rush, 4 TD's), the Packers return to Lambeau for their only HG in a 5-wk span. They welcome a Colts tm that failed to cover for the 1st time in 11 attempts as a HD LW against the Chiefs who finished with a 422-277 yd edge (QB Luck sk'd on 6 occasions). While the Colts can go all out with a bye wk on the horizon, they may find it difficult to find success against a GB tm that's on a 7-3 ATS run as a NDIV HF. **FORECAST: GREEN BAY by 13**

OTHER PLAYS

Atlanta at TAMPA BAY - Thursday - After getting back on track a wk ago against the Packers in dramatic fashion (GW TD pass w/:31 left) for their 6th victory in the past 7 matchups, the Falcons head to Tampa to take on a Bucs squad that's now delivered 3 straight in the series including a 31-24 win at the Georgia Dome in TY's opener as a 2' pt dog. Despite a massive 626-270 yd deficit LW at home against the Raiders, OAK needed a late TD (1:45 left) in OT to escape with the win. Although the Bucs clearly need a win here to stay within reach of the NFC South, neither has done well in their respective roles as TB is 7-22 ATS as a HD while ATL has delivered on just 2 of their L/16 as a favorite. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday on either your VIP Debit System or through the Marquee 7-pk.**

KANSAS CITY by 10 over Jacksonville - Following their 36-22 defeat last Thur to the Titans in a game that they were dominated much more than the final score would indicate (JAX 134 ttl yds, 2 TD in the final 5 minutes), the Jaguars now head to Arrowhead with major questions about HC Bradley's tenure (OC fired following the most recent loss). After and up & down 2-2 start to the ssn that saw a pair of road defeats to HOU & PIT, the Chiefs have now rattled off 3 straight victories following LW's win in IND where they had a 422-277 yd edge despite losing QB Smith and RB Ware in the gm due to concussions (CS). With the Jags on just a 4-9 ATS run heading into this contest and KC proving that they're capable of stringing together big winning streaks in the past (10-0 SU/7-3 ATS run to end the '15 reg ssn), there's only one way for us to lean in this one.

MINNESOTA by 10 over Detroit - Following a 7 pt loss last week in HOU where the Lions saw their 3-gm winning streak come to end (DET 289-269 yd edge), they now head to MIN to take on a Vikings team that came out victorious in both matchups (SU & ATS) a ssn ago with an avg cover of 8.5 ppg. The Vikings meanwhile come into this contest on a short wk following their MNF meeting in CHI and attempting to get back in the win column after a dismal outing against the Eagles in Philly the wk prior. With MIN still being one of the better spread covering options in the entire league with great marks as a favorite (10-2 ATS) and vs their DIV (6-1 ATS) along with the Lions' struggles as a DIV AD (5-11 ATS), the smart money will be placed on the Vikings this weekend.

NY GIANTS by 1 over Philadelphia - Following a back and forth matchup LW in Dallas where the Eagles blew a 10 pt lead in the 4Q and eventually lost in OT (outgained 460-291), they now head back on the road to take on a well-rested Giants team (off their bye) that's carrying a 2-gm winning streak (2 gms back in the NFC East standings along w/PHI). While we'll go ahead and give the Giants the outright victory, the Eagles have delivered the series sweep in each of the past 2 ssn's by 15 ppg and have now covered 4 of their L/5 as a dog.

MIAMI by 6 over NY Jets - Following some early struggles where they earned just one win over the 1st 5 gms of the ssn (OT vs CLE), things shifted in more of a positive direction for the Dolphins prior to LW's bye as they rattled off B2B upset wins against the Steelers and Bills behind a now healthy OL and the emergence of RB Ajayi (just the 4th RB in the SB era w/consec 200+ rush performances). They now welcome a Jets squad that rallied back from a 20-7 HT deficit LW in CLE to earn their 3rd win of the ssn (RB Forte 82 rush yds & 2 TD). While the Jets earned the ssn sweep of the Dolphins a year ago (MIA going thru coaching change) and have done well as a DIV AD (16-5 ATS), new HC Gase now has his team believing in the system which should benefit MIA here.

Pittsburgh by 3 over BALTIMORE - With inj's mounting on both teams heading into their respective wks off, the Ravens return as a DIV HD for just the 2nd time in the past 8 ssn's to take on a Steelers squad that will still likely be without the services of QB Roethlisberger (CS) who had knee surgery prior to their Wk 7 loss to NE. While the Steelers come in on a solid 8-4 ATS run, their lack of success LY against BAL is worth mentioning (incl a 23-20 OT loss in PIT w/o Roethlisberger). With that being said, the Ravens are on quite the skid following their 3-0 start to the year (4 SU losses, 0-5 ATS) and do have a short wk on deck with a Thur Night matchup against the Browns. Although Landry Jones does not have a clear step down from Big Ben if called upon again in this one (29-47-281, 1-1 ratio vs NE), the PIT offense (still have RB Bell & WR Brown) should be able to victimize a Ravens defense that remains somewhat on the mend.

SAN DIEGO by 3 over Tennessee - After a big home performance last Thur against the Jaguars where they led 27-0 at the half (all'd just 60 ttl yds of off to JAX during that span), the Titans head back on the road where they've had solid success thus far with SU victories over DET and MIA along with a tightly contested loss to HOU (tied at 21 apiece before a HOU PR TD). The Chargers meanwhile saw their 2-gm winning streak come to an end LW in DEN as QB Rivers was int'd on 3 occasions in the 8 pt loss (SD 20-15 FD & 369-324 yd edges). While SD does come in on a solid 9-3 ATS run, their ability to hold onto 4Q leads (4 blown TY) and the Titans' super running game (#3 NFL at 152 ypg) has us taking the points in this one.

Denver at OAKLAND - SNF - Crucial matchup in the very competitive AFC West! After losing B2B contests against the Chargers and Falcons following their 4-0 start, the Broncos have hit their stride once again following their MNF win over the Texans and dishing out some much-needed revenge LW to the Chargers behind another big performance from their defense that forced 3 int's incl one brought back for a TD (8 TD's by DEN def in the L2Y). The Raiders meanwhile come in after another successful road trip to the East with B2B wins over the Jags and LW against the Bucs in OT where they had a substantial 626-270 yd edge (QB Carr franchise-best 513 pass yds) but all'd TB to stay in the gm thanks to an NFL record 23 penalties (200 ttl yds). While OAK does appear to be the real deal so far in '16, it's worth mentioning that the visitor has cashed in each of OAK's matchups so far TY. **Call your VIP Debit Card for tonight's Marquee Winner!**
