### KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Green Bay over DETROIT - SNF** - Following their 5th consec win a week ago against the Vikings where QB Rodgers threw 4 TD's and ran in another, the Packers head to Ford Field looking to seal the deal for their 5th NFC North Title in the past 6 seasons. Standing in their way will be a Lions squad that comes into this matchup on short rest after their MNF tilt with the Cowboys and potentially on a 2-game losing skid. In their earlier meeting in '16, the Packers jumped out to a commanding 28 pt lead in the 2Q before having to hold off a late DET charge (pulled within a TD w/3:34 remaining, DET 418-324 yd edge). With outright wins in 20 of the previous 25 matchups and a solid 23-11 ATS run inside of the division, we expect the Packers to continue their hot streak here as they roar into the playoffs.

**FORECAST: GREEN BAY by 10**

**3★ SAN DIEGO over Kansas City** - After an easy home win against the sliding Broncos that ensured them a playoff berth for the 3rd time in the past 4 ssn's, the Chiefs head out West to take on a Chargers squad that they were able to get past in the '16 ssn opener despite a substantial 24-3 deficit in the 3Q. The Chargers meanwhile return home after giving the Browns an early Christmas gift (CLE's 1st win of the ssn despite SD finishing with a 356-251 yd edge & recording 9 sks). With the Chargers playing with a ton of emotion in quite possibly their final game in SD with rumors of a move to LA resurfacing (beat MIA by 16 as a 2' pt fav LY in FHG) and the Chiefs potentially watching the scoreboard to see if OAK slips up in DEN, we'll ride with the dog in this one as they attempt to send their SD fans out with one final victory.

**FORECAST: SAN DIEGO by 3**

### OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ NY Giants (+) over WASHINGTON** - After blowing their chance at controlling their own destiny the week prior in the Monday Night loss to the Panthers, the Redskins got back into the win column against the Bears behind a huge day from QB Cousins. The Giants meanwhile blew their own chances at winning the NFC East outright thanks to an early deficit last Thur in Philadelphia in the eventual 5 point defeat (NYG 24-15 FD & 470-286 yd edges). In their earlier matchup in September, the Redskins prevailed late in a game that featured 5 different lead changes in the 2H. While WAS has a solid 8-3 ATS mark against DIV foes and the Giants potentially resting starters after clinching a Wildcard berth, a 9 pt Vegas line for the Redskins to overcome against their rival is a bit steep in our opinion.

**FORECAST: WASHINGTON by 3**

### OTHER PLAYS

**TENNESSEE by 6 over Houston** - Following a costly outing in JAX where the Titans were held to just 263 yds and lost QB Mariota to a ssn-ending leg inj in the process, TEN returns to Nashville to take on the AFC South champion Texans who escaped with a 2 pt win against the Bengals (Top LP 3.5★ Winner on the Under). In their earlier meeting this ssn the Texans jumped out to a 14-0 lead in the 1Q but needed a 67 yd PR TD at the end of the 3Q to get the 7 pt win (HOU 359-320 yd edge). While HOU does have a solid 8-2-1 ATS mark inside of the division, their struggles TY on the road (2-5 SU/ATS, -10 ppg & -39 ypg) along with nothing left to play for before next week's Wildcard matchup (likely to rest starters) has us leaning with TEN to get the job done in this one with Matt Cassel making his 1st start under center (79 car sts w/NE, KC, MIN, BUF & DAL).

**Buffalo by 7 over NY JETS** - Following their 5th loss in the past 6 matchups against the Patriots where they were held to just 3 pts and 242 tll yds in the 38 pt loss, the Jets face a familiar foe in Rex Ryan who was the HC here from '09-'14. Despite 589 yds of offense a week ago against the Dolphins, the Bills were unable to hold onto the late lead in their eventual OT loss. In their previous meeting back in Wk 2, the Jets jumped out to a 20-7 lead in the 2Q and held on late for the 6 pt win (BUF fired their OC after the gm). With this very well being Ryan's last hurrah as the man in charge with the Bills, we'll go ahead and give them the 7 point road edge here as he walks away with a victory vs his former squad.

**Baltimore by 6 over CINCINNATI** - Following a last second defeat a week ago in PIT that saw them eliminated from a potential playoff berth (Steelers GW TD pass w/09 left), the Ravens head to Cincy in search of their 1st ssn sweep of the Bengals in 5 yrs (19-14 home win at the end of Nov). CIN meanwhile let a win slip through their fingers a week ago in HOU as they missed the GW 43 yd FG on the final play of the gm (CIN 294-250 yd edge). With the Bengals battling thru their 1st losing ssn since '08 and being on a 4-12 ATS run overall, the Ravens get the job done here by a TD as they have clearly been the stronger team throughout the year and are attempting to send WR Steve Smith out on a winning note.

**INDIANAPOLIS by 7 over Jacksonville** - After an 8 pt loss in the Bay Area against the Raiders where their defense was gashed for 459 yds, the Colts return home eliminated from playoff contention for a 2nd consec ssn. The Jaguars meanwhile ended their 9 gm skid LW in Doug Marrone's 1st gm as Interim HC with a 21 pt win over the Titans (JAX 416-264 yd edge). In their previous meeting across the pond in England, the Jaguars escaped with the narrow FG victory despite entering the 4Q with a 17 pt lead (JAX 331-284 yd edge). However, with JAX on a rough 7-14 ATS run and the Colts' recent overall success inside of their division (15-6-2 ATS), it's hard not to back the favorite in this one with JAX still in the mix for a Top 3 draft pick.

**PHILADELPHIA by 7 over Dallas** - The Eagles got back into the win column last Thur against the Giants as they jumped out to an early 14-0 lead before having to hold on late (24-15 FD & 470-286 yd deficits). The Cowboys meanwhile head to Philly following their MNF matchup with DAL and having nothing to play for after clinching the #1 seed in the NFC. In their earlier meeting in DAL, the Cowboys were fortunate to get both the win and cover as they scored the final 10 pts in regulation and eventually won it in OT (DAL 460-291 yd edge). With the Cowboys having dropped each of their past 4 heading into their MNF tilt with DET and potentially limiting the reps of their starters, we'll go ahead and give the Eagles the 7 pt edge here.

**MINNESOTA by 3 over Chicago** - Following a 13 pt defeat LW in Lambeau against the Packers (MIN 446-348 yd edge) for their 8th loss in the past 10 contests, the Vikings return home to take on a Bears squad who ran into an angry Redskins squad at Soldier Field (outgained by just 20 yds in 20 pt loss). In a surprising outcome earlier in the ssn, a then 5-1 Vikings squad went into CHI on MNF as just a 4 pt favorite and were handily beaten 20-10 while being outgained by a 403-258 yd margin in the process. While there is revenge on the mind of the Vikings, we'll back the underdog Bears who are on a 4-1-1 ATS run and have moved the ball with much more success (22 ppg, 388 ypg) in QB Barkley's 5 starts.

**TAMPA BAY by 7 over Carolina** - The Bucs took a major hit in their playoff aspirations a week ago in the Superdome against the Saints. The Panthers meanwhile saw their 2-gm winning streak end LW at home against the Falcons as QB Newton was forced into 2 crucial int's in the 17 pt defeat. In their earlier meeting back on MNF in Oct, the Bucs were able to take advantage of a Newton-less Panthers squad that mustered just 14 pts in the home defeat (CAR 4-0 TD deficit). With the defending NFC Champs on the outside looking in for the postseason with a 6-9 record, they could very well pack it in early here against a Bucs squad that needs to deliver the win and get some help to earn a spot in the postseason.

**PITTSBURGH by 17 over Cleveland** - After a big win against the Ravens LW in Heinz Field (GW TD pass w/09 remaining) which gave them their 2nd AFC North Title in the past 3 ssn's, the Steelers welcome a Browns team that avoided a spot in NFL history with their 1st win of the ssn a week ago against the Chargers (SD 356-251 yd edge). In their prior meeting just over a month ago in CLE, the Steelers were able to come away with a 24-9 (-8) victory despite just 313 yds of total offense (Browns allg 399 ypg on the ssn). With the Browns still within reach of the 1st overall pick in next year's draft, we'll go ahead and back the Steelers in this one despite not having much to play for as they've now come out victorious in 28 of the past 32 meetings by more than 10 ppg.

**ATLANTA by 4 over New Orleans** - Following their playoff clinching victory a week ago against the Panthers where they surpassed the 30 pt/400 yd mark for the 6th time this ssn, the Falcons return home not only searching for the #2 seed and a playoff bye but also the ssn sweep of the Saints for the 2nd time in 3 yrs. In their earlier meeting in the Superdome on MNF, ATL ran the ball at will with 217 yds on the ground (7.0 ypc) in the 45-32 win. The Falcons can actually thank the Saints for their NFC South Title after NO was able to move past the Bucs a week ago by a TD. While we'll go ahead and call for ATL to continue their winning ways, their 9-17 ATS mark as a favorite along with the Saints' 8-1 ATS run as a visitor will have us taking the points here.

**New England by 12 over MIAMI** - The AFC East Champion Patriots head to South Beach following their first cover in 7 matchups against the Jets where they finished with a 325-242 yd edge and forced 4 TO's in the easy 38 pt victory. A comeback OT victory in BUF (RB Ajayi 3rd 200+ yd rush gm of ssn) followed by a loss by the Broncos to the Chiefs saw the Dolphins earn the 6th and final spot in the AFC Playoffs. In their previous meeting back in Wk 2 without the services of QB Brady, the Patriots jumped out to a commanding 24-3 HT lead before having to hold on late in the 7 pt victory (bhp QB Garoppolo hurt following 3 early TD passes). After dropping their final 2 ssn ago (resting key players) to fall back into the #2 spot and eventually losing in DEN to the Broncos (AFC Championship), we expect Belichick and company (11-3 ATS run) to come out firing on all cylinders here as they try and learn from LY's costly mistake while earning the #1 seed in the AFC in the process.

**Arizona by 3 over LOS ANGELES** - Despite blowing a 21-10 lead in the 4Q a week ago against the Seahawks, the Cardinals were able to prevail on the final play of the gm (GW 43 yd FG) and do some damage to SEA's potential 1st Rnd playoff bye in the process. The Rams meanwhile head into play on a 1-8-2 ATS run following a blown lead in the final moments to the 49ers (SF 314-178 yd edge). In their earlier meeting this ssn in the desert, the Rams took advantage of 5 ARZ TO's in the 17-13 (+9) upset win (ARZ 420-288 yd edge). While the Cardinals clearly look like the stronger team on paper with Top 10 units on both offense and defense, their 2-7 overall ATS run along with the Rams' tendency to play their division rivals tight will have us stopping at a FG lean with the visitor here.

**Seattle by 17 over SAN FRANCISCO** - After ending their 13-gm losing skid a week ago against the Rams (also beat LA in the opener) thanks to a late TD drive and GW 2 pt conversion (SF 314-178 yd edge), the 49ers return home a loss away from securing the 2nd overall pick in next year's draft. The Seahawks meanwhile were tripped up LW at home against the Cardinals (ARZ GW FG as time expired) despite FD and yardage edges. In their prior meeting back in Sept, the Seahawks jumped out to a 37-3 lead into the 4Q before SF tacked on a pair of TD's and 122 of their 254 tll yds during their final 2 possessions. With the #2 spot in the NFC still in the mix for SEA (needs a loss by ATL) along with SF's miserable overall spread run (3-11 ATS), the Seahawks (12-6 vs NFC West) could very well name the score in this one.

**Oakland by 3 over DENVER** - The Broncos offense may be pictured on some local area milk cartons following a 3rd consec dismal performance against the Chiefs where they were held to just 246 yds in the 23 pt loss (7.6 ppg over L/3). The Raiders meanwhile come into this matchup after getting a costly victory a week ago against the Colts (459-391 yd edge) as they lost QB Carr to a broken leg in the process. In their earlier meeting inside of the "Black Hole" the OAK running game bludgeoned the DEN defense to death with 218 yds on the ground and a 10 pt win. While a victory here by OAK would allow them to earn the AFC West Title and the #1 seed in the AFC, they'll need to do it with Matt McGloin (6 sts w/OAK in '13) as he goes against a Top 10 but banged-up DEN defense. However, with covers in just 1 of their past 5 division HG's for DEN and so much at stake for the Raiders (OAK 9-1 ATS run in AG's), we expect OAK to rally behind their bhp QB in this one and get the job done.
