## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Washington over COLORADO** - UW is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series as P12 rivals, winning/covering by an avg of 32/17 ppg! The Huskies were well on their way to a cover LW vs Fresno before they literally called off the Dawgs to start the 3Q (FSU scored final 9 pts for the backdoor cover). The Buffs were trampled in LY's P12 Title gm and Washington is just as strong, while Colorado is vastly different, particularly on the defensive side of the ball. QB Browning is completing 70% of his passes and while he has just a 4-1 ratio, Colorado has two new starting CB's this year. Huskies HC Petersen is 27-13 as an AF and Washington has dominated this series making this our top selection of the week on these pages.

**FORECAST: Washington by 21**

**3★ San Diego St over AIR FORCE** - This is the MW opener for these two and SDSt has dominated in conf play, winning 18 of the L/20 (28-13-1 ATS conf run). HC Long knows how to defend the option and SDSt has won the L/6 in the series (5-1 ATS). The Falcons enter off a physical tighter than expected matchup LW in Ann Arbor (trailed by 3 in 3Q) before Michigan closed out the scoring with 13 consec pts. The Aztecs meanwhile made it 3 straight to begin the ssn and 2 in a row against the P12 with their 3 pt home upset of #19 Stanford (+8', GW TD w/:54 left, 353-254 yd edge). With SDSt now looking like a NY's 6 bowl contender and the Falcons 7-19 ATS off a SU loss, we see no problem leaning with the visitor here and making the Aztecs a key selection.

**FORECAST: San Diego St by 14**

**3★ MARYLAND over Ucf** - These schools met for the first time last year with Maryland winning on the road in 2OT. Both have their conference openers on deck. While each enter fresh off bye's, UCF has played just one game, back on September 2nd, which does give Maryland a rare GUB advantage this far into the season. The Terp's lost starting QB Pigrome in the opener, but rFr Hill has proven to be a competent replacement, hitting 84%. UCF QB Milton hit 76% in his lone game, but wasn't sacked, while Maryland's veteran DL enters with 9 sacks (10.1%). This is the Knights road opener (5-16 SU). Maryland's opening season win over Texas looks even better now and the Terp's appear to be one of the most improved teams in nation and we'll gladly back them laying less than a td!

**FORECAST: Maryland by 10**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Texas Tech (+) over HOUSTON** - These schools last met in 2010, but Houston HC Applewhite was on the Texas coaching staff from 2008-'14. Tx Tech led 42-24 mid 3Q over Ariz St, but needed a 12pl/90 yd drive to score the GW td w/1:55 left. QB Shimonek threw for 543 yards with a 6-0 ratio. The Red Raiders are travelling for the first time and have their huge B12 opener vs Oklahoma St on deck. The Cougars enter off a dominant performance in their Bayou Bucket rivalry as new starting QB (A&M transfer) Allen hit an incredible 31-33-309-2-0. The Cougars do have a trip to Temple on deck. The Red Raiders are 7-2 as an AD, while Houston is 3-10-1 as a HF. Tx Tech HC Kingsbury knows he's on the hot seat and can't afford to lose this game. We'll gladly take the points and won't be surprised at an outright upset.

**FORECAST: Texas Tech by 3**

**2★ STANFORD over UCLA** - Surprisingly this is Stanford's home opener and it appears to have come at the right time following their road defeat LW against SDSt where their offense was held to just 8 FD's and 254 yds. While the Bruins offense appeared to be awake in a rare 9am PST start (45 pts, 633 yds), the defense was sleepwalking throughout in the 3 pt defeat at Memphis (all'd 48 pts & 559 yds). With 8 consec covers in this series including a 9 pt road win LW in Pasadena, we'll go ahead and back a Cardinal squad in this one who have covered 11 of their past 14 off a SU loss.

### SEPT 21 THURSDAY

**Temple at USF** - The home team is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series. Both programs have new head coaches and this is the first conference game for both. This could very well determine the winner of the AAC East Division as these were the two favorites entering the season. It took three games, but USF finally looked like the team everyone expected entering the season, easily cashing our Fri night Marquee (\$15 thru office) last week. Temple still hasn't performed up to their expectations, including in their win over winless UMass last week. USF is 9-1-1 as a HF, but HC Strong is just 4-14-1 ATS at home vs foes off a SU win. Temple is 12-5 as an AD.

### SEPT 22 FRIDAY

**Virginia at BOISE ST** - HC Mendenhall is familiar with Boise St from his days at BYU (2-2 SU/1-3 ATS). UVA is 3-13 SU in road openers with their L/win in '11 but has covered 3 straight. QB Benkert is coming off a school rec 455 pass yds in their 38-18 (-10') home win over UConn. Boise St was w/o QB Rypien (CS) LW and we went against the Broncos for a Thurs night Marquee win in their 28-14 (-15) home win over NM. BSt was actually outg'd 277-264 & outFD'd 18-12. The Broncos last hosted an ACC foe in '10, beating #10 VT 33-30 (-1'). BSt is on an 0-11 ATS run at home. UVA is 19-11 as a dog and 8-4 as an AD.

**Utah at ARIZONA** - The Wildcats come in on a 4-1 ATS series run and had no issue getting past the Miners LW in El Paso behind 6 TD's from QB Dawkins (AZ 501-218 yd edge in the 47 pt win). Dawkins wasn't the only QB that posted big numbers a wk ago as Huntley recorded 4 TD's in Utah's 38 pt win over SJSt (501-263 yd edge). While the Utes are making the road trip South on short rest, both tms have a bye week on deck. Despite being 6-3 ATS at home in weekday gms & 16-8-1 ATS as a HD, the Wildcats are on a 8-19 overall ATS run while covering just 5 of their past 18 vs the P12.

### SEPT 23 SATURDAY

**Wake Forest by 5 over APPALACHIAN ST** - These universities are just 92 miles apart and this is their 23rd mtg overall but WF's first trip to Boone (L/gm in 2001). LY App St hosted their 1st ever P5 conf schl but lost 45-10 (+3') vs Miami. App St may have been looking ahead LW as a 22 pt fav vs TXSt. They needed a stop at the 1 yd line on the final play to pull out a 20-13 win and the Mountaineers were outg'd 385-283. Now they step up their competition against a WF squad who has outscored their foes 141-27 & have outg'd foes by 188 ypg. Surprisingly App St has the edge on OFF & D. WF is 12-3 as a dog and 7-1 ATS away. App St is 1-8 ATS at home.

**Duke by 4 over N CAROLINA** - This is the earliest matchup for the Victory Bell in series history. Duke has won 3 of the L/5 incl LY when they got the gm deciding td w/2:10 left to win 28-27 (+11'). LTH Duke allowed 66 pts which was their most all'd s/'95. QB Surratt ret'd from an ankle inj to throw for 257 in the Heels' win vs ODU. NC led 39-7 at half with the only pts all'd on a KR. Duke is 3-0 ATS this yr after their 28-14 (-13) home win vs Baylor. The Blue Devils will look to get the ground game going with RB's Shaun Wilson & Brittain Brown and they avg 241 (4.6) rush ypg while NC allows 176 (4.6) rush ypg. Duke is 18-8 as dogs, 15-7 ATS on the road and on an 35-18-1 ATS run while NC has 3 straight non-covers at home.

**Michigan by 8 over PURDUE** - It's homecoming weekend in West Lafayette. Both schools have a bye on deck and this is the first true road game for Michigan. Purdue looks like one of the most improved teams in the nation under new HC Brohm. While the offense was expected to improve, the defensive improvement is alarming as they're holding opponents to 167 ypg below their avg (#15 FBS)! They easily cashed our 'Underdog POW' on these pages last week in their outright upset at Mizzou, finishing with 477-203 yd & 26-10 FD edges. Michigan led by just 3 late 3Q vs Air Force as they're offense has just 1 td in 20 red-zone trips this year. The Wolverines are just 5-13 as an AF. The Boilermakers are just 4-19 as a HD, but HC Brohm is on a 18-7-1 overall ATS run (3-0 TY).

**GEORGIA TECH by 10 over Pittsburgh** - These 2 have split their 4 ACC mtgs with Pitt winning the L/2 by a FG in each. GT is 3-1 ATS in those mtgs. This is both tms ACC opener. Pitt has ply'd B2B tough gms vs Penn St/OKSt & has to switch gears from the Cowboys vaunted pass attack to GT's potent triple option. HC Narduzzi pulled QB Browne in the 2Q of LW's blowout loss and bkp Ben DiNucci did guide td drives on 2 of his F/3 possessions. GT is off an unscheduled bye. BC gets the call to win by double digits.

**Penn St by 10 over IOWA** - This is the B10 opener for both schools. Penn St is attempting to win 4 in a row SU in this series for the 1st time s/'84-'95. Iowa's win over N Texas last week could be costly as both RB's Wadley & Butler were injured (CS). While frosh RB's Young & Kelly-Martin were able to fill in nicely, PSU is allowing just 3.0 ypc. The Nittany Lions enter essentially off a bye following their 56-0 win over Ga St. The Hawkeyes are allowing just 97 (4.0) rush ypg. The Nittany Lions are travelling for the 1st time and HC Franklin is just 1-5 SU/2-4 ATS in road openers. Iowa is 7-3-1 as a HD.

**CLEMSON by 31 over Boston College** - Clem is 6-0 SU/3-2-1 ATS in this series (avg win by 18.8 ppg). LY, down 3-0. Clem scored 35 unanswered pts and went on to win 56-10 (-17). The Tigers, are coming off B2B tough gms vs Aub & L'ville. The Tigers have outg'd foes by 297 ypg and are holding foes to just 223 ypg. BC trailed just 14-13 3Q LW vs ND then all'd td's on 5 of 6 possessions. Run D has been a staple of the Eagles D under HC Addazio, but they've allowed 279 (6.1) ypg, 170 ypg more than they all'd LY and ND ran for 515! BC is 7-2-1 as an AD. Clem is in a L'ville/VT sandwich.

**FLORIDA ST by 7 over Nc State** - NCSSt is just 2-8 SU and hasn't won in Tallahassee s/'05 but they are 12-3-1 ATS in this series. LY FSU trailed or was tied for the F/56+ minutes then went 83/5pl for the gm deciding td (24-20, -6). FSU has had their L/2 gms cancelled so they've had time to prep True Frosh QB James Blackman who will be making his first start against a Wolfpack DL loaded with NFL talent. NCSSt is 11-5 ATS on the road. FSU is 9-13 as a fav vs ACC foes. This is NCSSt's road opener and also FSU's home opener thanks to the cancelled games.

**GEORGIA by 5 over Miss St** - MSt has not won in Athens since 1956, dropping 9 str trips incl their L/mtg, a 24-10 loss in '11. The Bulldogs looked like the real deal LW in their 37-7 (+7) home win over LSU. MSU held 465-270 yd & 25-13 FD edges and held RB Guice to just 76 yds. They will need a repeat performance vs the Dawgs' Chubb. UGA is off an easy win over an FCS foe. The Bulldogs have held foes to 255 ypg less than their ssn avg (#6 FBS) and allow just 71 (2.3) rush ypg incl holding ND to 55 (1.5) in week 2 and that same Irish squad ran for 515 on BC LW.

**SOUTH CAROLINA by 12 over Louisiana Tech** - These 2 haven't met s/'95. Since 2000 (not incl instate rival Clemson), SC is 17-5 ATS when hosting non conf FBS foes. SC not only lost LW 23-13 (-5) at home vs Kentucky but also lost WR Samuel to a broken leg (OFY). The Cocks run game has been stagnant, avg just 86 ypg (3.2), 48 ypg less than LY, but LT is all'g 204 (5.4). LT is ply'g B2B road gms and are off a huge revenge win over CUSA rival WKU.

**TENNESSEE by 24 over Massachusetts** - First mtg. UMass was a surprising 3-0 ATS vs SEC foes LY (avg loss by only 11.7 ppg). Tennessee is off an emotional loss to Florida 26-20 (+4') despite the Vols having outgained the Gators 442-317 if you remove the 63 yd hail mary that won the game. UMass, despite being 0-4, has been fairly competitive, losing all 4 by 10 pts or less and even outgained 2 of their foes. QB Ford threw for a car high 377 yds LW vs Temple and has a 6-1 ratio on the ssn. The Vols are 1-4 ATS when hosting non P5 FBS foes and the non covers are by 13 ppg. Tenn is in a tough UF/UGA sandwich and UMass enters with an extra day of rest/prep.

**West Virginia by 24 over KANSAS** - This is the B12 opener for both schools and each has a bye on deck. Kansas is on a 3-1 ATS run in this series. West Virginia enters fresh off an easy FCS win, while Kansas saw their road losing streak swell to 42 straight. The Mountaineers are avg 583 ypg and rank #21 FBS avg 157 ypg more than their foes allow, while the Jayhawks are allowing 435 ypg and rank #114 FBS allowing 96 ypg more than their foes avg. West Virginia QB Grier is hitting 66% with an 11-2 ratio & Kansas has our #126 pass eff D. Kansas is on just a 9-18-1 overall ATS run.

**Florida by 10 over KENTUCKY** - UF's 30 gm series win streak is now the longest active in the FBS and the Gators are 9-1 ATS in the series. LY UK trailed 45-0 until a gbg td drive w/4:27 left. The Wildcats win over SC marks the first time since Bear Bryant was their HC that they beat an SEC foe not named Vandy 4 consecutive years. The Gators ply'd w/o 9 ply'rs (incl RB Scarlett & Calloway, CS) vs Tenn & they were outgained 442-317 until a 6/3 yd Hail Mary got them a 26-20 (-5) win. UK is 13-24 ATS vs SEC East foes. The Wildcats have been outscored 125-13 in the 1Q the L/8 mtgs vs the Gators. The Gators are 1-3 ATS in road openers and are coming off an emotional win, but they are 5-0 SU/ATS when following Tenn with KY. UF is 15-6-1 ATS vs SEC foes while UK is just 3-11-2 as a HD.

**LOUISVILLE by 35 over Kent St-** After 3 straight against P5 foes, Louisville is taking a step down in competition this week. UL was outmatched LW vs Clemson's vaunted DL. QB Jackson was harassed into mistakes and hit just 21-42-317-3-1. We hope you took advantage of the FREE September 5★ LW as we went against the Golden Flashes who were blanked 21-0 (+14) at Marshall. Kent has yet to score a td vs an FBS foe and is being outgd'd by 240 ypg. UL is on a 3-9 ATS run and is just 17-31-1 as a DD fav vs FBS foes.

**Ohio by 3 over E MICHIGAN** - This is the MAC opener for both. EM comes in rested off a bye after upsetting Rutgers 16-13 (+5), their first ever win over a P5 team. Ohio is ply'g their 2nd road gm in 3 wks and are off their own win over a P5 team, beating Kansas 42-30 but unlike EM was a 7' pt HF. The Bobcats had won 6 str mtgs in the series but are out for revenge after being upset LY 27-20 (-7) at home. Ohio is 4-1ATS on the MAC road and EM has opened the HF, a role they are just 2-5 in the L/6 yrs but did cover their opener as a 14 pt HF over Charlotte. While EM has the defensive edge, including our #27 pass eff D but are allowing 147 ypg rush including 4.5 ypc. Ohio has the offensive edge, avg 206 ypg rush including 4.6 ypc led by RB AJ Ouellette (203, 6.2). We will lean with the dog here, Ohio by 3.

**CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over Miami, Oh** - This is the MAC opener for both tms. CM had won 3 straight mtgs until LY. The Redhawks are 12-5 as an AD. CM is 2-7 ATS in MAC play. Both are off losses to foes they have struggled against. Miami is off their 12th straight loss vs rival Cincy, in the Battle for the Victory Bell. This year's loss was even more devastating as they were a 5 pt HF and lead 17-6, 4Q before allowing 2 td in the final 2:52, incl a 12 yd IR td w/1:07 left. CM is led by former Michigan QB Morris who is avg 323 ypg pass (8-3 ratio) and Miami has our #59 pass eff D. MU QB Ragland is completing just 51% and CM has our #12 pass eff D.

**VIRGINIA TECH by 24 over Old Dominion** - First meeting between these 2 schools that are both located in VA but 315 miles apart. After falling behind 39-7 to North Carolina LW, ODU turned to 17 year old true frosh QB Steven Williams and he did throw 2 td passes. HC Wilder says he will be the starter going forward. VT QB Jackson has an 8-0 ratio and WR Phillips had a school rec 14 catches LW in their blowout win over East Carolina. The Hokies have covered their L/6 vs FBS foes while the Monarchs are 0-6 SU/2-4 ATS when traveling to a P5 conf foe w/ every gm decided by 11+ pts and they are on an 0-9 run as a DD Dog. VT is just 18-30-4 ATS vs non conf foes. VT does have Clemson on deck while ODU goes into a bye.

**CHARLOTTE by 3 over Georgia St** - This is the pillow fight of the week with both tms winless including losses vs FCS foes. The only prior mtg was in the '15 opener and UC won 23-20 (+7) in the 49ers' FBS debut. The 49ers have lost their L/6 games SU/ATS going back to LY incl LW's loss vs FCS NC A&T. The Panthers are ply'g B2B road gms after getting crushed at Penn St LW 56-0 (+37). UC has yet to beat an FBS foe at home (0-10 SU/2-7-1 ATS), while GSt is 11-3 ATS on the road, this is their first time ever as an AF and we feel Charlotte gets their first FBS home win and will gladly take the points.

**INDIANA by 21 over Georgia Southern** - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. The last time Indiana saw the option was '13 when they allowed 444 (6.3) rush and lost outright as a double-digit favorite to Navy at home. Both schools enter fresh off bye's, so the Hoosiers have had extra time to prep for the unique offense. After allowing 292 (5.7) rush vs Ohio State in their opener, Indiana held another Power 5 conf foe Virginia to just 55 (2.2). QB Lagow threw for 410 yds vs the Buckeyes, but struggled against the 'Hoos and Ramsey came off the bench to hit 80% w/2 td's. Ga Southern has just our #72 ranked pass eff D. The Hoosiers do have a trip to PSU on deck and are just 1-4 as a HF. GS has another bye on deck, is 8-5-1 as an AD.

**BUFFALO by 7 over Fau** - The only prior mtg was in '15 and UB won 33-15 (+2). FAU is just 7-36 SU on the road. UB is on a 7-13 ATS run but have covered 4 str including all 3 TY. Both tms enter off FCS foes and have their conf openers on deck. FAU returns to the road for the 2nd time in 3 weeks & their last road trip was an extended stay in Wisconsin, due to the Hurricane as they had to delay returning home until mid-week following the game.

**NEBRASKA by 14 over Rutgers** - It's homecoming weekend in Lincoln. Rutgers is travelling for the first time and has lost 4 of their L/6 road openers including B2B by 30 ppg. Despite a 384-213 yard edge Nebraska lost to a non-P5 at home for the first time s/2004 last week. They were also held scoreless in the 1H at home for the first time s/2007. Two of

QB Lee's three int's were returned for td's as even the tutelage of noted offensive HC Riley hasn't helped his penchant for turning the ball over. Rutgers counters with our #20 pass eff D & held their own vs UW QB Browning week 1. The Scarlet Knights enter off an easy FCS win. The Huskers are 5-11-1, but Rutgers is 2-7 as an AD.

**MIAMI, FL by 17 over Toledo** - UM won the only prior mtg 24-14 ('87). Toledo last ply'd a P5 schl in '15 and beat #18 Ark and Iowa St in B2B wks. This is actually Miami's 1st gm against FBS competition as they've had their L/2 cancelled. Toledo won a shootout over Tulsa 54-51 (-8.5) behind QB Woodside's schl rec 6 td passes and 458 yds. Tol finished with a 679-548 yd edge but needed a GW fg with no time left. The Canes' have one of the top D's in the ACC. UM has won 8 str non-conf home gms vs FBS foes by 22 ppg (L/loss in '11 vs Kansas St). The SU winner is 95-46-2 ATS in HC Richt's gms and the Canes are 11-4-1 as a HF vs FBS foes.

**NEW MEXICO ST by 21 over Utep** - UTEP is going for their 9th str L-10 rivalry win. The visitor is 7-3-2 ATS. LY NMSt was down 24-3 at the half and never got closer than 14 pts. UTEP hung with AZ for 1Q LW before allowing 28 unanswered. The Miners were ply'g w/o QB Metz and were outgained 501-218. Coming off their big upset win over rival NM, NMSt was prime for a letdown but only lost to Troy 27-24 (+7). QB Rogers threw for 331 yds & 3 td's. NMSt is 3-0 ATS with all 3 gms being decided by 6 pts or less. The Aggies also fared much better when ply'g a P12 foe earlier TY, only losing to ASU by 6 pts & holding a 149 yd edge. UTEP is dead last in the FBS on OFF, avg 250 ypg less than foes allow. NMSt is 5-1 ATS at home. UTEP comes in with extra rest.

**NAVY by 10 over Cincinnati** - The last meeting between these schools was all the way back in 1956, but Cincy HC Fickell prepped for the Middle option twice as DC at Ohio St in '14 & '09. Navy has a huge sicked edge entering fresh off a bye, while the Bearcats are playing their third straight away game and enter off their emotional Victory Bell rivalry win after coming back from a double digit 4Q deficit and scoring the GW td on a 14 yd IR td w/1:07 left. Cincy is allowing just 3.8 ypc, but their offense is avg just 270 total ypg. The Middies are 9-4 as a HF, but the Bearcats are 6-3 as an AD.

**OHIO ST by 42 over UNlv** - This is the first ever meeting between these schools. Ohio St HC Meyer was 2-0 SU/ATS vs UNLV while the HC at Utah. It took the Bucks a little while to pull away from Army last week following their emotional loss to Oklahoma, but they finished with a 586-278 yard edge. QB Barrett completed 76% and UNLV enters with just our #90 ranked pass eff D. True frosh RB Robbins avg 13.2 ypc last week & the Rebels allowed 309 (5.1) vs FCS Howard week 1. While UNLV is avg 351 (7.3) rush ypg, OSU has 1 of the best DLs & allowed just 61 (1.9) rush ypg vs Indy & Oklahoma. Meyer is 44-17-1 ATS vs non-conf foes and the Rebels are 4-9 as a double-digit non-conf dog. It will take more than being fresh off a bye to keep UNLV competitive in this game.

**WYOMING by 10 over Hawaii** - First meeting in the past 3 snns between these 2 conf foes. Hawaii heads to Laramie following a bye week and a 2-1 SU/ATS start to the ssn. This is the Cowboys' third straight home gm and they have a strong home field edge due to altitude (8-2 ATS run). One of those defeats did come LW against the Ducks however as NFL prospect Allen was held to 9-24 for 64 yds & 2 TO's in the 36 pt beatdown. With UH on just a 13-27-1 ATS run overall and the Cowboys having covered 7 of their past 8 off a SU loss, we see no reason not to lean with the home tm in this one.

**TULSA by 14 over New Mexico** - Tulsa is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series, winning each by 19+ points, including the last meeting in 2015. The Golden Hurricane saw the option twice LY (1-1 SU/ATS). New Mexico is on the second of B2B away games and while they have 2 extra days of prep, our Thurs night Marquee winner saw QB Jordan go down with inj (CS). It's all offense and no defense for Tulsa as they avg 196 ypg more than their foes allow (#13 FBS) while allowing 166 ypg more than their foes avg (#123). They were up 28-7 late 1H, twice let 2H leads slip away and allowed the GW 33 yard fg with no time left in their loss at Toledo last week. They're avg 364 (5.5) rush ypg led by RB Brewer (447, 4.6) but New Mexico is allowing just 78 (3.0) rush ypg. The Lobos are 13-6 as an AD, but did go 0-2 ATS last year on their 2nd straight road game, while the Hurricane is on a 20-11 overall ATS run.

**LSU by 20 over Syracuse** - This is the 4th different series venue for these 2 w/LSU winning the L/mtg in '15 at 'Cuse 34-24 (-24). LSU was to feel upset and embarrassed after getting crushed LW 37-7 (-7) at Miss St. The Tigers were outgained 470-265 and had trouble containing QB Fitzgerald. Now they face a similar QB in Dungey who ran for 111 & threw for 279 in LWs win over CMU. Cuse (-9') actually trailed 17-10 before scoring the L/31 pts. The Orange will have to contain RB Guice but they returned their entire front 7 from LY and have held foes to 44 (2.6) rush ypg. They did upset #17 VT LY. LSU is just 3-6 ATS vs non-conf P5 foes.

**TROY by 13 over Akron** - 1st mtg. Troy is 0-4 as a non-conf HF vs FBS foes, while Akron is 13-8 as an AD, but both teams are 0-3 ATS TY. Troy is off their conf opener, where they hung on to win 27-24 at New Mexico St as a 7' AF. The Zips are off a rare home game vs a P5 school, losing to Iowa St 41-14 as a 10.5 HD. Akron has their MAC opener on deck while Troy has a trip to LSU. While we look for Troy to win, they have opened as an over 2 td favorite and that is just a bit too much.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 13 over bowling green** - LY was the inaugural mtg and MT won on the road 41-21 (-6). BG was shutout in the 2H despite never punting (3 SOD & 2 int's). MT ply'd w/o QB Stockstill LW at Minny & lost 34-3 (+9') as bkp Urzua had just 134 pass yds & 2 int's. WR Richie James had just 1 catch & was inj'd (ankle, CS). BG was crushed LW 49-7 (+21) at NW and is 0-3 SU/ATS on the ssn. Stockstill could return (CS) and BG allows 310 pass ypg and has our #118 pass eff D. This is BG's 3rd tough road tilt (at Mich St, at NW) in 4 wks. Both tms have their conf openers on deck. MT is 8-20 ATS vs FBS non conf foes and 12-22 ATS at home. BG is 10-6-1 ATS on the road.

**Auburn by 16 over MISSOURI** - This is the Tigers first trip to Columbia & just the 2nd overall SEC matchup. Their only other mtg was in the '13 SEC Title gm won by Aub 59-42 (E). Mizzou QB Lock has struggled mightily vs FBS competition and partly for that reason we went against them LW on these pages for the Underdog POW (and a 3★ LPS) and picked up an EASY outright winner, 35-3 (-7). Lock has completed just 50.6% of his passes & has a 12-14 ratio vs FBS foes. Aub is off an underwhelming win over an FCS foe. Aub is on a 0-6-1 ATS run and 7-15 ATS vs SEC foes. Mizzou has a bye on deck and is ply'g their 4th str home gm.

**SMU by 7 over Arkansas St** - The last meeting between these schools took place in 2007. SMU enters off an emotional rivalry loss for the 'Iron Skillet'. Trailing by just 1 they allowed a 38 yard td pass between four DB's on the final play of the 1H and then the game snowballed in the 4Q. Ponies QB Hicks has thrown for 300+ yds vs both FBS foes, but is completing just 48% however Ark St has just our #100 ranked pass eff D. The Red Wolves enter fresh off an FCS foe with a bye on deck, but are just 2-8 as a non-conf AD.

## MICHIGAN STATE +3' over Notre Dame

**MICHIGAN ST (+) over Notre Dame** - We won our 'Underdog POW' on this game last year as MSU snapped a 3 game series losing streak. Notre Dame is on the second of B2B away games, while the Spartans enter fresh off a bye. MSU also started 2-0 in last year's forgettable season, but this year seems different as Sparty is +258 ypg & has held both foes to their season lows in yards. Irish QB Wimbush set a school record with 207 (9.9) rush yds and RB Adams finished with 229 (12.7) as Notre Dame had two-200 yd rushers for the first time in school history in their win at Boston College. The final score was a bit misleading as Notre Dame led by just 1 mid 3Q. The Irish are just 7-11 as a favorite away from South Bend, while MSU is 4-2 ATS off a bye and 4-0 as a HD. Sparty HC Dantonio is in his preferred role as a dog and we will let history repeat itself by using Michigan St again in this matchup as our Underdog Play of the Week!

**Alabama by 23 over VANDERBILT** - The last mtg between these 2 was in '11 (34-0 Bama, -29). Bama outgained CSU 216-11 in the 1Q and led 17-0 but only won 41-23 (-28'). The 'Dores are coming off a 14-7 win over Kan St where they were outgained by 7 yds & outFD'd by 2, but KSt threw 2 int's & was SOD at the VU19 on the final drive. QB Shurmur has an 8-0 ratio but the 'Dores run gm hasn't got off the ground, avg just 103 (3.0) ypg and RB Webb is being held to 2.8 ypc. Now they face the vaunted Bama run D that allows 81 ypg (2.7). Vandy's young front 7 will have to deal with Bama's potent run game and Vandy just allowed Kan St to run for 201 (5.7). Bama is 7-1 as an AF and ply'g their 'true' road opener.

**Army by 3 over TULANE** - These schools last met in 2010. Both run the option and enter off physical road losses (Ohio State/Oklahoma) which were close early on. The Green Wave shut down Navy's option to the tune of just 3.7 ypc two weeks ago and is allowing 4.4 ypc while Navy is allowing 5.1 ypc. Tulane may get the return of starting QB Banks, who missed last week (CS). This is the second of B2B away games for the Black Knights, while Tulane has a bye on deck. The Green Wave is 9-15 as a HF and Army has a veteran squad that is well rehearsed in the option while Tulane is running it for just its 2nd year. We'll gladly take the points.

**OKLAHOMA ST by 13 over TCU** - Oklahoma St returns home following B2B away games, while TCU enters off their 'Iron Skillet' rivalry win and has a bye on deck. The Pokes, led by QB Rudolph (72%, 11-1 ratio) avg 607 ypg and it will be interesting to see the matchup against our #11 ranked pass eff D. The Horned Frogs have held each of their FBS foes to season lows in yards. TCU QB Hill is completing 75% and OSU has just our #45 ranked pass eff D. The Pokes are 30-16 as a HF, but the Horned Frogs 15-6-1 as an AD.

**WKU by 3 over Ball St** - WKU doesn't look like the same team we remember under former HC Brohm as new HC Sanford has struggled to get this offense going. QB White, who threw 37 td's LY has just 1 in 3 gms and WKU's run gm avg just 86 (2.6) ypg. Ball St is off a win over an FCS foe while WKU is off an emotional 23-22 (-6') home loss to CUSA rival LT. The Toppers led 22-13 but lost on a GW fg as time expired. The Hilltoppers are 15-7 SU in reg ssn non conf action and 4-0 SU/2-2 ATS vs MAC foes. Ball St is 32-13 as a road dog incl a 5-0 run.

**NORTH TEXAS by 10 over Uab** - This is both tms CUSA opener. Overall UAB is 2-0 and won the L/mtg 56-21 (-6') in '14. UAB is coming off their 1st win over an FBS foe since their rebirth, beating new FBS member Coastal Carolina 30-23 (+1'). The Blazers were outgained 327-274 & outFD'd 22-18 but took advantage of 3 CC int's. NT actually led Iowa 14-10 at the half and trailed just 17-14 4Q but lost 31-14 (+21') though Iowa did finish on the NT 2. UAB avg 255 (5.0) rush ypg but NT only allows 141 (3.4) rush ypg. NT is 9-4 as a HF.

**Utah by 13 over TEXAS ST** - This is UTSA's 1st trip to San Marcos (49 mile trip). The only prior mtg was in '12 and UTSA won 38-31 (+1'). UTSA is off an easy win over an FCS foe. TXSt was on the door step of a major upset LW vs App St but was tackled at the App St 1 on the gms final play. Former Miss St transfer QB Damian Williams was solid, throwing for 260 yds and the Bobcats actually held a 385-283 yd edge.

**† Texas A&M by 3 over Arkansas** - This game is being played in Arlington, home of the NFL Cowboys. A&M has won all 5 SEC mtgs (2-2-1 ATS) incl 2 in OT. LY Ark led 17-10 but A&M scored 28 unanswered after Ark was SOD at the 1 and won 45-24 (-6'). These two comb for 1,000+ yds in 4 of 5 gms (1,041 avg). The Aggies had a slow start for the 2nd str week LW vs Louisiana. They trailed 17-14 at the half but outscored LA 31-0 in the 2H. True frosh QB Mond ply'd the whole gm and threw for 301 w/3 td's & may have solidified his spot. Ark is fresh off a bye. A&M has held foes to just 77 (2.7) rush ypg but none of their foes are known for running the ball and Ark avg 183 (4.8) rush ypg. A&M is 15-2 SU/12-5-1 ATS in Aug/Sept gms. Ark is 13-7-1 as a dog.

**RICE by 7 over Fiu** - The only prior mtg took place in '14. Rice led 17-0 1Q but was only up 24-17 4Q then held FIU scoreless and won 31-17 (-7'). FIU is 4-12 SU but also 8-2-1 as a CUSA AD. After getting embarrassed by Stanford in Australia Rice looked much better in their win at UTEP, but surprisingly looked flat in their Bayou Bucket rivalry. FIU enters fresh off an unscheduled bye due to Hurricane Irma while Rice is finally ply'g their home opener.

**SOUTH ALABAMA by 6 over Idaho** - This is the 3rd str HG for SA and they're off an easy FCS win. ID is on the 2nd of B2B AG's. They are off a heartbreaking loss (399-347 yd edge), as they led WM 28-19 into the 4Q as a 20' pt AD but allowed the final 18 pts. Jags are ply'g with revenge after losing for the 1st time in this series LY. ID's Lineham struggled in LY's mtg, hitting just 50% with 3 int's. SA has just our #110 pass eff D but SA has faced a tougher schedule incl a ranked Oklahoma St and so are a bit better than the numbers show.

**LOUISIANA by 1 over ULM** - Sun Belt opener for both. This rivalry is known as the 'Battle on the Bayou' & the schls play for the Wooden Boot. LA is on a 5-3-1 ATS series run, but the visitor is 17-2-1 ATS! LA is 8-1 SU, but their largest margin of victory at home in that span is just 6 pts. The last time LA won by DD's ('12) ULM pulled the outright upset as a 2 td dog

After giving a high powered Memphis team a challenge in the opener (lost 37-29 as a 25 pt AD), ULM struggled LW after an unscheduled bye. LA has shown some offense this year but have needed to stay close in games as they have allowed 56 ppg. LA did lead Texas A&M 21-14 at HT LW but the Aggies were led but a Frosh QB making just his 2nd start of the ssn.

**Oklahoma by 28 over BAYLOR** - OU had a slight hangover early, tied at 14 in the 2Q last week vs Tulane before pulling away & finishing with a 631-282 yard edge! QB Mayfield is the early Heisman leader and the Sooners offense is #8 FBS avg 232 ypg more than their foes allow. Baylor is still searching for their 1st win under new HC Rhule. QB Solomon DNP last week (conc) and Zach Smith hit just 12-34 with a 3-3 ratio including a crucial pick 6 down four 4Q. The Bears have struggled defending the run, all'g 201 (4.3) rush ypg & OU is avg 5.4 ypc vs teams not named Ohio State. This is Baylor's 3rd home game in 4 weeks, while the Sooners have a bye on deck. The Sooners are on a 5-1 overall ATS run (3-0 TY), while Baylor is on a 1-8 overall reg ssn ATS run (0-3 TY).

**Usc by 27 over CALIFORNIA** - The Trojans are off a solid win over Stanford & along with a 20T victory over Texas and are travelling for the 1st time in '17. Cal meanwhile is at home for the 3rd straight wk. After getting past FCS member Weber St by 13, the Bears surprisingly followed that up with an outright home upset (+7) of Ole Miss (held Rebels scoreless for final 43 minutes). While the Trojans have won 13 consec in this series, they've also gone on to cover 10 of the past 12 vs Cal including a 45-24 victory a ssn ago (-16'). At just 7-16 ATS as a HD, we expect the recent series trend to continue in this one as the Trojans continue to build the championship resumé.

**WASHINGTON ST by 30 over Nevada** - The Cougars are playing 4th str HG following an easy 29 pt win over the Beavers where they finished with a 492-357 yd edge (QB Falk 6 TD passes). Nevada meanwhile suffered quite the embarrassing home defeat LW against Idaho St as a 30 pt fav (trailed 30-7 in 3Q). Nevada has their MW opener on deck and are on 5-10 ATS run overall. While WSU is in a P12 sandwich with USC on deck, Falk and company should be able to have their way with the Wolf Pack secondary which is among the worst in the entire FBS (allowing 284 ypg, 64%, 6-1 ratio TY).

**Oregon by 16 over ARIZONA ST** - UO is on an outstanding 8-1-1 ATS run in this series including an easy 54-35 win LY in Eugene during a year of struggles for the Ducks (just 1 of their 2 P12 wins in '16). In a shootout that featured 97 ttl pts and 1109 ttl yds the Sun Devils fell short by a TD LW in Lubbock (ASU on a 1-5-1 ATS run dating back to LY). While the Ducks are on their 2nd of B2B AG's and this is ASU's lone HG in a 4-wk stretch, we'll back HC Taggart here as he's a solid 25-7 ATS run in away matchups (Oregon is 7-1 ATS away prior to B2B HG's).

**Utah St by 4 over SAN JOSE ST** - This is UTSt's 2nd straight road gm and 3rd in 4 wks. LW's visit to Wake was one to forget however as the Aggies were outgained by a 588-267 yd clip and trailed 36-0 5 minutes into the 3Q. The Spartans didn't fare much better in their road matchup against Utah LW thanks to an offense that was forced into 5 TO's and 5 sks while being held to just 30 rush yds on 37 att. UTSt has covered their L/4 MW road openers but are 2-9 ATS in their past 11 conf gms overall. However, with 6 consec SU wins incl a 3-0 ATS run in the series, we expect the Aggies to get back on track in this one.

**East Carolina at CONNECTICUT** - This game was originally sked for Nov 4, but moved to this week due to numerous changes resulting from the effects of Hurricane Irma. Since becoming AAC rivals in 2014, the home team is 3-0 ATS, covering by an avg of 25 ppg! The Pirates dominated last year, allowing a season low 295 yards, but that won't be the case here as they're allowing their foes 172 ypg more than their avg (#125 FBS) and fired their DC before last weeks loss to Va Tech. East Carolina is 0-3 SU for the first time s/2004. The Huskies ran for 207 (5.0) in last weeks loss at UVA and East Carolina is allowing 308 (6.0) rush ypg! **3★ † Baltimore over Jacksonville - London - 9:30am EST** - The Ravens had no issue moving to 2-0 a week ago against the Browns behind a defense that forced 5 TO's (BAL has forced 10 TO's & all'd just 10 pts so far in '17). ## OTHER PLAYS

**LA Rams at SAN FRANCISCO - Thursday** - Following a pair of rough defeats to start the ssn in which they've failed to reach the EZ, the 49ers should be more than happy to welcome the Rams in this one as SF's lone 2 victories of a year ago came against LA (incl a 28-0 MNF home win in the '16 opener). This appears to be a different Rams squad under rookie HC McVay however as while they come in at 1-1 following a narrow home loss to WAS, the offense appears to be much more consistent with 66 total pts thus far. While the Rams have struggled in DIV AG's with just a 10-22 ATS mark, something will have to give here as the 49ers are on a 5-12 overall ATS run. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**INDIANAPOLIS by 3 over Cleveland** - The Browns head to IND on just a 3-9 ATS run following their struggles LW on the road to BAL (QB Kizer 15-31-182, 3 int in 1st car road st). The Colts also moved to 0-2 on the year w/o QB Luck thanks to an int thrown in OT by QB Brissett (started over a benched Tolzien from the wk prior, outgained 389-266 by ARZ). IND has won 7 of the L8 meetings in this series but have covered just 1 of the L5. While neither team has impressed, we're leaning with the Colts in this one as they're 11-2 ATS as a HD and CLE is in a rare road favorite role (just 2nd time in L5 yrs, lost 24-6 as 4 pt fav in '14 to JAX).

**Pittsburgh by 10 over CHICAGO** - Following a rough outing LW in Tampa where former Buc QB Glennon was an intricate part of a 4 TO day, the Bears return to Soldier Field where they fell just short of knocking off the defending NFC Champ Falcons back in Wk 1 (at ATL 5 yd line on last play trailing by 6). The Steelers remained undefeated on the ssn by taking advantage of a Vikings team missing their starting QB (held MIN to just 9 pts & 238 ttl yds). While CHI has done well as a HD with a 5-1-1 ATS mark, we expect the Steelers to go into the "Windy City" and get the cover here now that RB Bell (91 ttl yds) appears to have found his footing after being limited early (pressn holdout).

**NY JETS by 1 over Miami** - After a rough start to the Dolphins' campaign where they lost their starting QB in camp and saw their home opener rescheduled due to Irma, MIA hung on for the 2 pt win after the Chargers missed the potential 44 yd GW FG w/0:55 left (MIA outgained 367-336). They're now back on the road again to take on a Jets team that struggled LW on the West Coast vs OAK as the Raiders piled up 45 pts & 410 yds in the 25 pt win. With all of the stories coming out that the Jets are tanking in '17, this appears to be a winnable game as they've covered 8 of their L10 as a DIV HD. With the Dolphins headed to London next week before FINALLY getting back to South Beach for their 1st HG of the ssn (Oct 8th!!), we'll back the home team here against a road-weary MIA squad.

**BUFFALO by 3 over Denver** - Big win for the home dog Broncos LW as they put up 42 pts while holding DAL to just 268 ttl yds in the 42-17 win. DEN is now on the road for the 1st time in '17 to take on a Bills squad that dropped to 1-1 on the year LW in Charlotte despite holding the Panthers to just 3 FG's & 255 ttl yds. While the Broncos are a solid 6-2-1 ATS as an AF, the Bills have done well as a HD (10-4 ATS) and have a run game (#1 in NFL LY) capable of controlling the clock and escaping with the outright victory (DEN #28 rush D in '16).

**NEW ENGLAND by 17 over Houston** - Following a decisive win LW in the Superdome behind their vengeful offense (Brady 447 pass yds, 3 TD), the Patriots return to Foxboro where they were embarrassed in the ssn opener against the Chiefs (all'd 42 pts & 537 ttl yds). Fortunately the NE defense takes on a much weaker offense TW in the Texans who have a rookie QB making just his 2nd career start (Watson 15-24-125 pass yds, 49 yd rush TD in 13-9 last Thur vs CIN). With the Patriots having delivered in their past 4 meetings with HOU (3-1 ATS) by 20 ppg incl a 27-0 shutout LY w/o QB Brady, we'll back them here (14-4 ATS run) against a visiting squad that's failed to cover 8 of their L10 as a NDIV AD.

**CAROLINA by 10 over New Orleans** - It's been another rough start to the ssn for the Saints following a 16 pt home loss LW against an angry Patriots squad. Things don't get any easier here as they head to CAR to take on a 2-0 Panthers defense that has given up just a FG apiece in wins over SF & BUF. While the Saints are an extremely solid 8-2 ATS as an AD, it's worth mentioning that they have a long road trip on deck to take on Miami in London. With the Panthers having gone 11-5 ATS as a DIV HF and winning 4 of the past 5 against NO in Charlotte, we'll lean in their direction here.

**Tampa Bay by 3 over MINNESOTA** - The Bucs head up North with some confidence knowing that they've covered 6 of their L8 as an AD (if applicable) including 5 outright upsets. TB

saw their 1st action of the ssn LW vs CHI (Irma Wk 1) and came away with a solid victory behind a defense that forced 4 TO's. The Giants meanwhile come into this matchup on short rest following a MNF tilt vs DET. While the NYG have a current 8-4 ATS run as of presstime, this is the only HG over a 4-wk span to start the ssn for the Eagles. With PHI having covered 5 of the past 6 against the Giants including 3 straight at home by a 26-9 avg score, the smart money will be on them as they look to rebound following LW's defeat.

**Seattle by 3 over TENNESSEE** - While the Titans came into the '17 ssn as a potential playoff contender, their 1st HG this ssn vs OAK was quite a disappointment. They did bounce back LW however in JAX behind a dominant 2H where they posted 31 pts. Following an offensive struggle in Wk 1 vs GB where they failed to record a TD, the Seahawks nearly repeated the feat a wk ago against the 49ers before getting into the EZ w/7:06 for the eventual game-winner (held SF to just 248 ttl yds). With SEA on a 5-1-1 ATS run as an AD and the Titans covering just 1 of their past 6 as a NDIV HF, we'll go ahead and give the visitor the 3 pt edge in this one.

**GREEN BAY by 14 over Cincinnati** - Following an outstanding def performance in Wk 1 against SEA where they surrendered just 3 FG's in a 17-9 victory, the Packers were unable to continue the momentum LW in ATL as the Falcons jumped out to a 24 pt lead in the 11 pt win. GB now welcomes a struggling Bengals squad that's on an 0-2 skid (both at home) after their 13-9 loss to the Texans last Thur (CIN has yet to score a TD). With GB posting a 15-7 ATS mark as a HF and CIN failing to cover 14 of their L19, we'll favor the home squad by 2 TD's here.

**Oakland at WASHINGTON - SNF** - After an expected win a week ago against the Jets where QB Carr & WR Crabtree hooked up for 3 TD passes, the Raiders head East for a 2nd time in '17 carrying an excellent 13-3 ATS mark in road gms dating back to '15. The Redskins were also victorious LW on the West Coast against the Rams as an AD finishing with FD (19-13) & yard (380-329) edges. While the Raiders are clearly the more talented tm in this matchup, keep in mind that they are just 2-6 ATS vs the NFC and that WAS is still on a 15-6 overall ATS run. **Call the office on gameday at 11am ET for the Marquee Winner!**

**Dallas at ARIZONA - MNF** - The Cardinals are in the desert for the 1st time TY following road trips to DET (12 pt loss) & IND (3 pt win OT following a Colts int). The Cowboys meanwhile come in after a huge 25 pt road loss in DEN where they were outgained by a 380-268 margin while losing a handful of DB's to inj in the process. While DAL has a solid 6-2 ATS mark as a NDIV AF, the Cardinals (4 consec SU/ATS wins in series, 6 pt avg MOV) could force this matchup to go down to the wire with a 12-4 ATS record as a NDIV HD.
