KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Miami, FL over NORTH CAROLINA - UM is ply'g with revenge. We have gone against North Carolina 4 times in our LPS, and have won all 4 incl LW's 4★ LPS winner 59-7 (+20) loss at VT. The Heels are extremely banged up and used 3 diff QB's last week after QB Surratt hurt his ankle (CS). The Canes have won 11 straight since LY (8-3 ATS) which is their longest win streak s/01-'02. Miami is +105 ypg on the season while NC is -198 ypg in their L/4. The Canes have our #11 pass eff D and NC's QB's have comb'd to hit just 41% their L/3 gms. UM is 8-2 ATS in ACC road gms. NC is 0-6 as a HD and on a 1-7 ATS run. Miami has VT on deck. NC has a bye on deck but they are also decimated by injuries and have no bowl hopes. NC is 0-7 ATS vs P5 foes with the avg non-cover of 12.4 ypg! Could we go against NC again for our 5★ GOM?

FORECAST: Miami by 28

3★ OHIO ST over Penn St - College Gameday will be on hand. OSU is playing with legit revenge (HC Meyer 24-10-1 ATS) after last year's loss cost them a trip to the B10 Championship game and snapped their 4 game series winning streak. The Bucks enter fresh off a bye (3-1 ATS) and since losing to OU are arguably playing better than anyone in the nation. OSU is #2 in the FBS on OFF averaging 204 ypg more than their foes allow and #13 on D, allowing 109 ypg less than their opponent's average. QB Barrett has joined the Heisman discussion completing 67% with a 21-1 ratio and true frosh RB Dobbins is averaging an absurd 7.8 ypc. PSU enters off an emotional revenge game win vs UM, is #10 on OFF averaging 102 ypg more than their foes allow and #15 on D, holding foes to 95 ypg less than their average. It will be extremely tough for the Nittany Lions to put together A+ efforts in B2B weeks and they're just 2-8 as an AD, while the Buckeyes are 4-1 ATS as a favorite.

FORECAST: OHIO ST by 14

3★ San Diego St over HAWAII - The Aztecs have won all 5 MW mtgs SU/ATS by 25 ypg incl LY at home, 55-0 (-21). They do head to the islands off B2B losses at home to Boise & Fresno (held to just 3 pts & 255 yd vs the Bulldogs). The Rainbow Warriors are fresh off a bye but are just 4-18 ATS vs MW tms at home. The success for the Aztecs so far in '17 has come on the legs of RB Penny as he had at least 100 rush yds in their 6-gm win streak to start the year but has been held to just 53 & 69 yds in their past 2 defeats. Hawaii is allowing 207 (5.9) rush ypg in conference play. With 108 rush yds & a TD on just 8 carries for Penny in LY's 55-0 victory, we'll call for SDSst to re-gain their confidence with a statement win on the road.

FORECAST: San Diego St by 17

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★† Georgia over Florida - It's the "World's Largest Outdoor Cocktail Party" ply'd in Jacksonville. Georgia will be hungry after losing the last 3 of this series all by DD's. Also, a win puts the Dawgs in prime position to win the SEC East for the first time since '12. UF has lost B2B gms by a comb'd 3 pts. The Gators are -3 ypg on the season while the Bulldogs are +202 ypg and against 2 common foes (UT/Vandy) UGA is +36 ypg & +275 ypg while UF is only +10 ypg and +47 ypg. UGA has the edge on OFF, D & ST's and true frosh QB Fromm continues to improve (12-3 ratio). UGA avg 283 (5.8) rush ypg but was held to just 21 yds LY. UGA is #2 on D, holding foes to 169 ypg below their ssn average while UF is #75, allowing 7 ypg more than their foes' season avg. The Gators are just 1-5 as a dog while UGA is 4-1 as a fav and this is the year that the Bulldogs can bully the team that they've gotten bullied against the L3Y.

FORECAST: Georgia by 19

2★ Louisiana Tech over RICE - LT has won the L/3 SU/ATS in this series by an avg score of 60-21. The Owls average just 7.8 ppg in their L/5 and have topped 12 points just once all year. LT should enter in an angry mood after blowing an 11 point lead w/1:23 left and losing in 2OT vs Southern Miss. QB Smith should get back on track after LW's poor performance (11-28-194-0-1) against Rice who comes in #125 in our pass eff D rankings. The Owls are #126 on OFF, avg 116 ypg less than their foes allow. LT is #47 on OFF, avg 37 ypg more than their foes avg. The Bulldogs have the edge on OFF, D & ST's, is 16-9 ATS in road gms, and won't allow a DD lead to slip away this week.

FORECAST: Louisiana Tech by 20

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 26TH:

Toledo by 27 over BALL ST - Toledo has won 6 of the L/8 in this series and the visitor is 8-1 ATS. Rockets QB Woodside is #2 on the schools career passing yards list and they average 248 (5.3) rush ypg in MACtion. BSU is #100 in our pass eff D rankings and is allowing 186 (4.7) rush ypg in conference play. The Card's are being outscored by an average of 47-5 their L/3 games as the injury to QB Neal has clearly hurt and he remains out indefinitely. The Rockets are 7-1 as an AF and on a 21-12-1 overall ATS run, while BSU is 6-14 as a HD and on an 0-4 ATS run.

South Alabama by 4 over GEORGIA ST - GST is 3-1 ATS in this series as SBC rivals including covering 3 straight. QB Manning DNP (inj) LY as SA hit the GW fg w/02 left. We easily cashed a 3★ on these pages going against the Panthers as they were held to an FBS season low 307 yards in their 24 point home loss vs Troy. SA QB Davis is off his first 300 yard pass game of the season and RB Johnson became the schools career leading rusher last week. Manning is healthy this year and SA is just #87 in our pass eff D rankings, while GSU is #114. The Jags are 4-2 as an AF.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 6 over Eastern Michigan - NIU has dominated this series, winning 9 straight (7-2 ATS). The Huskies enter off an easy win at BG and are averaging 236 (4.4) rush ypg in MACtion, while EM enters off another emotional loss as they've now dropped 5 straight by a combined 20 points and allowed WM to rush for 220 (5.2) last week. This will be the Eagles fourth road trip in 5 weeks, while NIU is home for the lone time in a 4 week span. EM is 9-1 as an AD, and continues to keep games closer than expected.

Stanford by 24 over OREGON ST - Both teams return to action heading in different directions following a bye week as Stanford sits at 5-2 SU including 4 straight wins while OSU is 0-6 SU vs FBS foes TY (did cover L/2 gms vs P12 foes). The Cardinal have won 7 straight in the series but LY only won 26-15 at home as 16 pt chalk. Although the Beavers have done well as a conf HD by covering 5 of their past 6, Stanford is an impressive 19-8 ATS as a P12 away fav s/10 giving us some confidence in taking them here.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 27TH:

Florida St by 4 over BOSTON COLLEGE - FSU has won 7 straight in this series. BC has just 7 pts in the L/2 mtgs incl being shutout LTH and they've been held to 7 or less in 4 of the L/7. Both of these teams are better than their numbers suggest but they've faced the #1 and #2 overall toughest schedules. FSU's bowl hopes are now in red alert after losing LW to Louisville (L/3 losses by combined 13 pts). FSU was going in for the game deciding score but fumbled. BC is off a dominant performance (another outright winner as part of our Big Dogs!) in their win over Virginia (41-10, 512-247 yard edge) and are looking to pull an outright upset for the 3rd

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consecutive week. QB Anthony Brown returned from injury and had the best gm of his career, hitting 19-24 with 3 td's. The Eagles come in with our #1 pass eff D but also allow 224 (5.3) rush ypg. BC has covered 5 straight incl 4 as a dog while FSU is 0-4-2 ATS but their 2 SU wins did come on the road.

MEMPHIS by 11 over Tulane - Memphis is on an 11-3-1 ATS run in this series, defended the option 2 weeks ago, and enters off a weekday game. The Tigers rallied from a 17-0 halftime deficit to win at Houston last week as QB Ferguson threw for 471 yds and Tulane has just our #102 ranked pass eff D. Tulane was down 34-7 late 3Q last week vs USF, but showed no quit by rallying to lose by under a td as they gained the most yards the Bulls have allowed. The Tigers are just 1-6 as a weekday HF, while the Green Wave is on a 6-2 overall ATS run.

SMU by 6 over Tulsa - TU has never won 4 in a row SU in this series and SMU is on a 3-1 ATS series run. The Golden Hurricane is travelling for the third time in 4 weeks. TU enters off a loss at UConn where they trailed 20-0 mid 4Q. SMU enters off an OT win at Cincy. While both teams struggle on D, SMU is #16 in the FBS on OFF averaging 91 ypg more than their foes allow. The Hurricane is averaging 262 (5.3) rush ypg and the Ponies have allowed 249+ rush ypg 3 times including each of the L/2 weeks, but keep an eye on the status of RB Brewer, who is now on the injury report. TU is 10-4 as an AD, while the Ponies are 12-19 as a HF.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 28TH:

Tennessee by 3 over KENTUCKY - Tenn has owned this series, going 31-1 SU (KY won in '11). They are on a 17-4 ATS series run and have won the L/5 by 23 ypg. The Vols have won 14 consecutive quarters w/o an OFF td (only td LW came via IR ret td). Last week we went against KY on these pages and picked up an easy 2★ winner (upgraded to 3★ on our LPS!). The 'Cats were outgained 441-260 and lost 45-7 (+12). KY has been outgained by every FBS foe they've faced as they're -86 ypg. Tenn is -115 ypg on the season but they've faced a much tougher sked incl Bama & Georgia. RB Kelly has 615 (4.9). UK allowed just 74 (2.6) rush ypg in their F/5 but in their L/2 they've given up 248 (6.1). Tenn is 0-7 ATS on the season but we feel QB Guarantano will have a lot more success after facing Bama's D and UK is 0-5 as a fav. We won our 5★ GOY all the way back in 1986 in this series. Could the Vol's be our OCT GOM in '17?

SOUTH CAROLINA by 10 over Vanderbilt - SC is 22-4 SU all-time incl 8 str wins by 9 ypg although Vandy is 6-4 ATS. Vandy is out for revenge after losing LY's opener. Both tms come in fresh off a bye. SC is off B2B wins despite missing 3 starters on their OL and all 3 are still on the mend (CS). Regardless, SC should find running room against a D that has allowed 318 rush ypg vs P5 foes. Vandy is -328 ypg vs SEC foes while SC is -16 ypg against similar sked strength. The Cocks are #57 on D, allowing 18 ypg less than their foes avg while Vandy is #109, allowing 58 ypg more than their foes avg. The Dores are 0-4 ATS vs SEC foes TY.

AKRON by 4 over Buffalo - The home tm has won 6 str (5-1 ATS) in this series with UB RB Johnson rushing for a schl rec 282 yds LY. Akron is 2-7 ATS at home and while UB is 3-10 ATS on the road they are 3-1 TY but are ply'g B2B road gms. The Bulls who were down to their 3rd string true frosh QB suffered their first ATS loss at Miami LW. While UB QB Vantrease threw for 202 & 2 td he hit just 41% with an int. Akron is tied for the lead in the MAC East but suffered their first conf loss LW at Toledo. UB has the defensive (#79-#87) and OFF (#104-#115) edge, but much of that was due to their top 2 QB and while avg 404 ypg for the ssn had just 271 ttl yds LW. With the uncertainty of the UB QB poss we will lean with the home team.

Louisville by 2 over WAKE FOREST - UL is 4-0 SU but just 1-3 ATS in this series. LY WF led 12-3 at the half but fell apart in the 4Q which led to a deceiving 44-12 (+35) final score. Louisville barely avoided a 3rd straight loss last week by beating FSU on a gm winning fg w/05 left. QB Jackson has thrown for 2,478 w/a 17-5 ratio and has 868 (6.4) rush. The Deacons are off a misleading 38-24 (+5) loss at GT as they led 21-13 at the half then were down 7 but got SOD at the GT24. UL has the edge on OFF but WF has the edge on D & ST's and is at home. Lville is ply'g their 2nd UNSEC road game and are 2-10 ATS overall and 12-22-1 as a fav in ACC play while WF is on an 11-4-1 ATS run and 7-4-1 as a HD. With all that in the dogs favor we will lean with the Deacons.

MICHIGAN by 26 over Rutgers - It's homecoming weekend in Ann Arbor. After losing the initial B10 meeting, UM has won the L/2 by 56 ypg (avg cover by 28) including last years 78-0 final. The Wolve's enter off their worst loss since Harbaugh's first year roaming the sidelines after allowing a season high 506 yards including 224 (6.4) rush at PSU. Rutgers has won B2B B10 games for the first time despite getting outgained 474-217 and outFD'd 25-8 in their misleading win over Purdue. UM is #4 in the FBS on D, holding foes to 149 ypg less than their average, while the Scarlet Knights are #121 on OFF, averaging 85 ypg less than their foes allow. While the Wolve's OFF has struggled, they did rush for 271 (6.2) 2 weeks ago at Indy and should move the ball vs a Rutgers D that allowed 279 (6.8) rush last week. The Scarlet Knights are 4-7 as an AD.

MARSHALL by 23 over Fiu - Marshall was 4-0 SU/ATS in this series until LY when FIU pulled an outright upset. Last week we used Marshall as a 3★ LPS on Friday night and picked up an easy winner as The Herd dominated MT won 38-10 w/a 366-273 yd edge. Against that same MT team, FIU lost by 20 & was outgained by 120 yds. FIU is #11 in pass eff D and faces QB Litton who has a 13-3 ratio. The Herd have held 4 of their L/5 opponents to 10 pts or less and come in #44 on D, allowing 34 ypg less than their foes avg. FIU is #100 on OFF, avg 38 ypg less than their foes allow. Marshall is 6-1 ATS on the season incl 3-0 at home. FIU is off a bye but is 3-6-1 ATS on the road. Our Power Sweep subscribers won with Marshall as our Sept 5★ and the Herd is in the mix for our Oct 5★ GOM!

Appalachian St by 1 over MASSACHUSETTS - App St won the only prior mtg, which was in the 1AA (now FCS) Champ gm in '06. UMass is ply'g in their home stadium finale & have a trip to Miss St on deck. The Minutemen after 2 straight bye weeks got their first win of the ssn LW with a team record 670 yds of OFF, dominating SBC foe Ga Sthrn. AST is 12-6 ATS in reg ssn AG's incl 8-3 as an AF but have struggled on the road TY (0-3 ATS) winning only by 7 (-22) at Texas St & by 3 (-12.5) at Idaho. The Mountaineers are 4-0 in conf play & are in an SBC sandwich. They are allowing 3.7 ypc rush and UMass has avg 3.9+ their last 3 incl 7.3 ypc last week. UMass has had 5 gms this ssn with 413+ yds and have the offensive edge (#51-#80).

Virginia by 3 over PITTSBURGH - The home tm had won 5 straight (4-1 ATS) until LY when Pitt won 45-31 (-4) on the road. UVA still needs one more win to be bowl eligible after LW's 41-10 (+6) home loss to BC. The 'Hoos were outgained by 257 yds. QB Benkert had his worst start of the season, throwing for just 146 and should bounce back as Pitt has our #99 ranked pass eff D. Last week we used Pitt as a 2★ on these pages and not only did they cover, they pulled the outright upset 24-17 (+8). RB Darrin Hall went for 254 (10.6) rush yds and broke a century old school record w/a 92 yd td run. This is a must win for UVA with their L/4 games against much tougher foes. UVA is -21 ypg in ACC play but Pitt is -96. HC Narduzzi is 4-13 ATS at home.

CLEMSON by 21 over Georgia Tech - LY Clem led 23-0 with a 327-30 yd edge at the half before cruising to a 26-7 (-10) road win. Clem has won the L/4 home mtgs by DD and is 13-8 ATS in the series. The Home team is 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS. The Tigers are off a much needed bye after losing QB Bryant in their loss to Cuse. Clem has the top DL in the country and allows just 108 (2.9) rush ypg. GT avg 373 (5.8) rush ypg and is +135 ypg. Clemson is #3 on D, holding foes to 151 ypg below their average. Clemson gets extra time to prep for the option, has the edge on OFF, D & ST's and has ply'd the tougher sked but QB Bryant's status makes a huge difference. Our line is contingent on Bryant being under center.

Missouri by 13 over CONNECTICUT - These schools have just 1 prior meeting with Mizzou winning by a fg in '15. UConn is 1-6 SU/ATS vs P5 schools with the win coming last year vs UVA. The Huskies enter winners of 2 straight and while their win at Temple 2 weeks ago was misleading, they led Tulsa 20-0 last week and held on as QB Shirreffs is completing 68% w/a 13-4 ratio. Mizzou counters w/just our #121 pass eff D. The Tigers enter off an easy non-conf win vs ID, finishing w/658 yards, their most vs an FBS foe this year and UConn is #128 in the FBS on D, allowing 148 ypg more than their foes average. It's safe to assume this could be the highest scoring game of the weekend. Mizzou is 9-2 ATS vs sub .500 non-conf foes.

Oklahoma St by 13 over WEST VIRGINIA - WV is in revenge mode as they were 6-0 and ranked #10 in their loss last year. OSU enters off a physical OT win at Texas, is on the second of B2B away games, and has Bedlam on deck (4-2 ATS in the game prior). WV nearly let a more than 3 td 4Q lead evaporate vs Baylor last week. While both schools feature top 10 OFF's (OSU #3 averaging 179 ypg more than their foes allow, WV #7 averaging 128 ypg more than their foes allow), the Pokes have a HUGE edge on D as they're #18 in the FBS holding foes to 79 ypg less than their average, while the Mountaineers are #112, allowing 63 ypg more than their foes average. OSU also has our #8 ranked pass eff D, while WV is #51. The Mountaineers are a HD for just the fifth time in the L4Y.

Indiana by 7 over MARYLAND - It's homecoming weekend in College Park and Indy is on the second of B2B away games, enters off Michigan and Michigan St, and has Wiscy on deck. The Hoosiers gave MSU all they could handle last week, allowing them to score the final touchdown so they could get the ball back with a chance to tie. We cashed our Totals GOM on the OVER in MD's blowout loss at Wiscy last week as the Terps have mostly struggled under third string QB Bortenschlager. After facing the PSU, UM, and MSU D's their L/3 B10 games, Indy's OFF should fare much better vs a MD D that has allowed 518 ypg their L/3 games. MD is on a 4-11 overall ATS run, while the Hoosiers are 4-1 as an AF.

VIRGINIA TECH by 14 over Duke - VT is 14-2 in this series but has lost 2 of the L/4 by 2 & 3 pts. All of the L/4 gms have been decided by a fg or less. The dog is 4-0 with 3 outright upsets. Last week we used VT as a 4★ LPS and our customers got to sit back and relax as VT demolished NC 59-7 (-20), 4-2 LPS and our October GOM is this week! The Hokies have held 3 of their opponent's to a season low in yards incl LW vs NC (172). Duke has now lost 4 straight after being upset at home by Pitt. The Devils are -68 ypg vs ACC foes while VT is +99. Against that same NC team, Duke won by 10 pts but was only +11 yds. Huge technical edges favor the Blue Devils as they're 13-7-1 as a Dog vs ACC foes and 8-1 as a DD dog while VT is 10-21-1 as a DD fav and we'll back Duke in their preferred role.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 7 over Texas St - 1st mtg. TXSt enters fresh off a bye, while CC is off B2B AG's & is in their lone HG over a 4 wk stretch. This is the Chanticleers 3rd gm as a fav in their inaugural FBS ssn, but they lost both prior gms outright incl a 52-10 home loss to an FCS foe. Both tms have struggled on both sides of the ball with CC having the Off "edge" (#112-#129) & being almost equally bad on Def (TXSt #121-#123). CC has opened as a DD fav & we find it hard to give them that much of an edge.

Wisconsin by 34 over ILLINOIS - It's homecoming weekend in Champaign. UW is on a 4-1 ATS run in this series. We cashed another Early Bird winner on the Badgers as well as our Totals GOM on the OVER in their blowout win vs MD last week. IL scored a td w/:23 left in their loss at Minny costing us a 4★ LPS last week. The Illini allowed 292 (5.3) rush last week and UW is averaging 257 (5.5) rush ypg led by Jonathan Taylor, who tied an FBS record for fewest games needed by a freshman to reach 1,000 yards. IL leads the FBS with 14 true frosh starters and QB Thomas became their 21st player to see game action when his RS was burned last week. The Badgers are 6-0 as an AF, while IL is 3-7 as a HD. UW has been our fav 5★ team of all-time. Could we use them again for our OCT 5★ GOM? **Kansas St by 31 over KANSAS** - The Governors Cup is on the line in the 115th Sunflower Showdown as these schools have met every year since 1911! KSU was on a 7-0 SU/ATS series run until last year when KU, down 34-9, scored twice in the 4Q (34-19, +26). 'Cats QB Delton was much improved in his second start, nearly leading the upset over OU after completing 86% of his passes and rushing for 142 (5.3) and 3 td's. Ertz remains a ? (CS). The Jayhawks arguably are the worst team in the FBS, having gained a total of 127 yards their L/2 games incl a B12 all time low 21 yards LW! KSU is 48-24 ATS vs B12 foes and KU is on a 9-22-1 overall ATS run. We love series domination and could we use 1 of the best CFB coaches ever as our Oct 5★ GOM?

IOWA by 10 over Minnesota - The Floyd of Rosedale is on the line. Iowa is on a 7-2 ATS series run at home. This is a crucial game for both schools in terms of becoming bowl eligible. The Hawkeyes were without 2 starters on D including B10 leading tk'r MLB Jewell in their OT loss at NW last week, while MN had a tougher than expected time vs an IL team that has the most true frosh starters in the nation. The Gophers have struggled to run the ball against bigger DLs and Iowa still

allowed just 3.2 ypc last week despite being w/o their leader on D and he should return this week (CS). MN is on just a 7-12-1 overall ATS run.

WYOMING by 7 over New Mexico - LY WY all'd a schl record 568 rush yds vs the NM option. The Lobos are 12-5 SU/13-5 ATS in the series and have won the L/3 incl LY's 56-35 (+3) home win in a meaningless gm for WY (already clinched division). The Lobos allowed a 21 pt 2Q outburst by Colo St in the 3 pt home loss last Fri (NM 450-411 yd edge). The Pokes meanwhile blew a 4 pt lead in the 4Q at Boise in the eventual 10 pt loss (QB Allen just 12-27 for 131 yds & 1-2 ratio). With Wyoming on an 11-2 overall ATS run in Laramie and having covered 4 consec overall coming in, we'll call for them to earn some revenge in this one against a Lobos squad that's now dropped gms in B2B weeks.

Arkansas St by 1 over NEW MEXICO ST - It's HC wknd in Las Cruces. Ast is on a 6-0 ATS run in this series, covering the L/3 since NMST re-joined the SBC by an avg of just 5.5 ypg. The Aggies enter fresh off a bye & this is their lone HG in an 8 wk stretch! The Red Wolves enter with 2 extra days of prep/rest following their 47-3 win over Louisiana, easily cashing our Thurs night Marquee on the UNDER! QB Hansen had arguably his best gm in LY's contest, compl a car high 74% & faces NMST with our #74 pass eff Def. The Aggies are 5-1 ATS as a HD. Ast has our #56 pass eff D and a slight Def edge (#94-#103). With NMST avg 4.2 ypc rush & Ast allowing 4.5, while Ast is avg 4.3 ypc & NMST allowing 4.7 ypc, this could be a long night for both defenses, so in an offensive shootout we will lean with the better offense (NMST #47-#65).

BYU by 9 over San Jose St - These two have split the 4 recent mtgs but the Spartans are 4-0 ATS, despite being a dog in all 4 (3 losses by 6 pts or less). The Cougars have dropped 7 straight games for the 1st time s/68 following a 2H no-show LW against ECU (outscored 23-7). The Spartans meanwhile enter fresh off a bye but are just 4-15 ATS as an AD. While we don't feel comfortable leaning with SJST, we don't feel encouraged with BYU's OFF as a DD favorite

Utah by 20 over UTEP - The home team has lost all 4 mtgs (0-4 ATS) in this series incl LY when UTEP got a GW td in 5 OT (52-49, +10). UTSA scored just 1 OFF td in LW's win over Rice. Tyrell Clay had 153 rush yds on just 11 carries and the RoadRunners did hold a 448-300 yd edge. UTEP enters off a much needed bye after putting up a ssn low 6 FD's and 147 yds vs S Miss. The Miners have been outgained by 240 ypg while UTSA has outgained foes by 155 ypg. The RoadRunners' D is #22 holding foes to 67 ypg below their avg and the top non P5 team in our pass eff D rankings at #20, while UTEP's OFF is dead last in the FBS, avg 187 ypg less than their foes allow. The Miners are 14-27-1 as a dog.

IDAHO by 2 over ULM - ID has covered all 3 since rejoining the SBC in '14. They enter off SEC Mizzou & this is their lone HG in a 4 wk stretch. ULM is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks & is on the 2nd of B2B AG's. Vandal RB Duckworth had a car high 121 rush yds incl a car long 55 yd td LW. ULM is 4-1 as an SBC AD incl an outright win at Louisiana TY. ID is just 10-19 ATS at home incl 1-3 TY. ULM opened conf play with 3 str wins but have lost their last 2 by 10 ppg. Hard to back either school, but due to ID's struggles at home we'll lean slightly with the Warhawks.

COLORADO ST by 15 Air Force - It's the battle for the Ram-Falcon Trophy. The series has been controlled by the home tm lately, going 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS. The dog has also covered the L/3. The Rams used a strong 2Q performance LW at New Mexico (21-3 run) before having to hold on late in the 3 pt win (CSU outgained 450-411). The Falcons meanwhile saw 3 different players surpass the 100 yd mark and hit a 30 yd FG as time expired (36-21 FD & 591-424 edges). While the Falcons are 18-9-1 ATS at a SU win, the Rams are 21-12 ATS at home and should be able to take advantage of an AF team ply'g their 2nd consec road gm. CSU also in a great situation after defending the option last week and AF has a HUGE gm vs a vastly improved Army team on deck!

SOUTHERN MISS by 10 over Uab - UAB won their L/3 trips to Hattiesburg. The Blazers bowl hopes were dented last week when they blew a 17-0 3Q lead to become the first ever FBS team to lose at Charlotte. S Miss comes in with momentum, having won 4 straight after rallying from down 11 with 1:23 left to beat LT in 2OT. SM is +69 ypg vs CUSA foes while UAB is -36 ypg. UAB is on B2B road gms and plays 4 of their L/6 on the road. UAB is 4-1 as a dog and we'll give a slight lean with the dog.

COLORADO by 7 over California - The Bears fell just short in their 2OT shootout LW in Berkeley against Arizona (Cal 35-23 FD edge). The Buffs meanwhile were blanked LW in Pullman against an angry WSU squad (lost 37-3 to Cal the week prior) being held to just 174 ttl yds for the contest. While Cal is 5-3 all-time in this series, their last visit to Boulder in '13 was a 41-24 defeat (1st loss there s/75). While Colorado has dropped 5 consec ATS in their home venue dating back to LY including an outright upset by Arizona (+6) a few wks back, keep in mind that the Bears have dropped 9 straight ATS in P12 AG's!

Nebraska +5' over PURDUE

Purdue is 3-1 ATS in this series as B10 rivals, including covering 3 straight. This is a crucial game for both schools in their quest to become bowl eligible. Nebraska enters fresh off a much needed bye after taking on arguably the top 2 teams in the conference in B2B weeks. The Blackshirts held their 3 prior foes to their season lows in yards. QB Lee is completing 60% with a 6-1 ratio his L/3 games and Purdue has just our #68 ranked pass eff D. The Boilermakers enter off B2B misleading finals on the road and continue to use a 2 QB rotation. They were outgained by 273 yards but only lost at UW by 8 and outgained Rutgers by 257 yards but lost by 2. This is a huge step down in competition for Nebraska. The 'Huskies are 16-6-1 ATS away from Lincoln and Purdue is 5-15 ATS home vs FBS foes. We'll call for the 'Huskies to pull the outright upset and make this our 'Underdog Play of the Week! **FORECAST: Nebraska by 4**

ARIZONA ST by 1 over USC - The Sun Devils have now delivered B2B outright upset victories against Washington and LW in SLC against the Utes (345-265 yd edge). They now play host to a USC squad that was throttled in their trip to South Bend thanks to 3 more TO's (19 on the ssn). While the Trojans are 14-3 in this series (incl 41-20 & 42-14 wins the L2Y), they have split the past 6 meetings overall. After USC clearly struggled the week after playing physical Utah the week prior, it will be interesting to see how well ASU handles that feat in this one.

Utah by 4 over OREGON - Following a narrow defeat 2 wks ago on the road at USC, the Utes couldn't get anything going in the return of QB Huntley LW against ASU as he hit just 19-35 for 155 yds & 4 int! The Ducks appeared to be almost one dimensional in LW's 17 pt defeat in Pasadena as frosh QB Burmeister finished with just 74 pass yds on 15 att (UO outgained 408-320). LY's matchup in this series saw 6 lead changes including 5 in the 4Q alone. The Ducks would get the eventual win with the GW 17 yd TD pass w/02 remaining. LTH the Utes put up 62 points, their most ever in a P12 gm. While UO is 7-2 SU in this series, we expect Huntley to play much better in his 2nd gm back and help Utah escape in Autzen.

NOTRE DAME by 7 over NC State - This is suddenly one of the most interesting games on the slate. LY's gm was held in nearly unplayable conditions directly in the path of Hurricane Matthew (10 fmbf's & only 311 yds). The only td came on an NCSt blk'd 16 yd PR and the Pack won 10-3 (-3). NCSt enters fresh off a bye while ND took advantage of a beat up USC squad, winning 49-14 (-3'). RB Adams has 967 rush yds on the season with a ridiculous 9.2 ypc but NCSt counters with an NFL level DL and allows just 91 (3.0) rush ypc. QB Finley has an 11-0 ratio, hitting 69% but faces our #34 rated pass eff D. ND has the edge on OFF, D & ST's and has faced our #15 sked while NCSt has faced our #36 sked. NCSt is 13-5 ATS in road gms and HC Doeren is 5-0-1 ATS off a bye. ND is 1-5 as a fav vs P5 foes.

WASHINGTON by 17 over UCLA - Following a shocking 13-7 road defeat as 18 pt chalk 2 wks ago in Tempe, the Huskies are back at home after their bye week to take on a UCLA squad that is 13-3 in this series including a 44-30 victory in the last Seattle matchup back in '14. The Bruins took advantage of a one dimensional Ducks team LW at home in the 17 pt win (408-320 yd edge). With UW looking to make a statement in their return to action and UCLA's porous 1-5 overall ATS mark against conf foes, we'll call for the home team to get the job done in this one.

TROY by 28 over Georgia Southern - It's HC wknd in Troy. The Eagles are on the 2nd of B2B AG's. GS is 0-2-1 as an AD TY. In a game featuring an option offense you would not be surprised if 1 team rushed for 7.3 ypc, except LW UM ass avg'd that "against" GS, while GS avg'd just 3.3 ypc in a game GS trailed 48-17 at HT. For the ssn GS is avg just 3.8 ypc, while allowing 5.4 ypc and has our #91 pass eff def. Troy is allowing just 2.8 ypc rush incl just 1.6 ypc in SBC play. With only Idaho on deck, the Trojans are in true revenge mode after LY's loss cost them a share of the SBC crown. GS fired their HC just before we went to press. We won a Marquee going against Troy 2 wks ago and won a 3★ on these pages last week going with them. Could we use Troy a 3rd str wk for our Oct 5★ GOM?

Michigan St by 8 over NORTHWESTERN - While MSU is travelling for the third time in 4 weeks, the visitor is 8-0 ATS in this series. Sparty enters off a physical come-from-behind win vs Indy, scoring both tds w/under 6 minutes left. NW enters off a physical OT win over an Iowa team that was without the B10's leader in tackles. This figures to be a low scoring game as MSU is #6 in the FBS on D, holding foes to 141 ypg less than their average, while the 'Cats are allowing just 95 (2.8) rush ypg including holding Wiscy to just 109 (2.9) their L/5 games. NW is 0-4 as a HD, while Sparty is 21-13 ATS away from East Lansing.

NORTH TEXAS by 14 over Old Dominion - 1st mtg. ODU has lost their last five, although they did outgain WKU last week 448-416. The Monarchs got a big boost from the return of All CUSA RB Ray Lawry from injury and he rushed for 166 (6.1). NT allowed a CUSA record 804 yards incl 447 (9.3) rush in their 69-31 (+3') loss at FAU last week. ODU true frosh QB Williams only hit on 47% of his passes but gets to face an NT defense that allows 276 pass ypg and is #90 in our pass eff D rankings. NT is #11 on OFF, avg 101 ypg more than their foes allow while ODU is just #114, avg 67 ypg less than their foes allow. NT is 6-3 ATS off a SU loss.

Texas by 9 over BAYLOR - BU is on a 7-3 ATS run in this series. Texas enters off physical down-to-the-wire losses in the RRR and vs OSU, while Baylor is still searching for its first win under new HC Rhule. The Bears were down by over 3 tds in the 4Q vs WV last week, but were a failed 2 point conversion away from sending the game into OT w/ 17 left as true frosh QB Brewer nearly led the comeback. The 'Horns are #25 in the FBS on D, holding foes to 57 ypg below their average including holding OSU to a season low 428. Texas true frosh QB Ehlinger will be taking on just our #122 ranked pass eff D this week, a vast difference than the #8 D he opposed last week. The Bears are 6-0 as a HD including 2-0 this year, but Texas is 17-11 as an AF.

Tcu by 14 over IOWA ST - It's homecoming weekend in Ames. TCU has exerted little effort the L/2 weeks after facing a Kansas St team w/a first time starting QB and OFF challenged KU. ISU is off to its best conf start in 15Y! This figures to be a low scoring affair as the Horned Frogs are #5 on D in the FBS holding foes to 142 ypg below their average while the 'Clones are #16, holding foes to 89 ypg under their average. TCU QB Hill is earning his 'thrill' nickname as he's completing 70% w/a 15-3 ratio and ISU has our #64 ranked pass eff D. TCU is 7-13 as an AF, but 2-0 this year, while the 'Clones are 6-2-1 as a HD but have failed to cover their L/2 in this role.

Fau by 10 over WKU - FAU has won the L/2 in this series and the dog is 6-1 ATS with 3 outright upsets. While it does seem that WKU has sorted out their early season struggles by winning their L/4, they've done so against the 3 worst teams in CUSA and 2 of those came by a combined 5 points. Last week WKU beat ODU by 4 pts but was outgained by 32 yds while FAU beat that same ODU team by 30 pts w/a 139 yd edge. FAU enters off a record setting performance in their win over NT. The Owls scored on their F/11 drives and put up a CUSA record 804 yards. RB Singletary has gone over 100 in 5 straight and has 809 (6.6) rush yds. FAU is #21 on OFF, avg 87 ypg more than

their foes allow. WKU is #104 on OFF, avg 43 ypg less than their foes allow. The Owls are 4-1-1 ATS on the road and WKU is a home dog for the first time s/15.

Washington St by 4 over ARIZONA - There is some warm and fuzzy feelings for us in this matchup with Arizona delivering 5★ GOY Winners over the Cougars way back in 1982 & 1983 (first 2 years of NC Sports)! Wazzu was able to rebound nicely following their 1st loss of the ssn 2 wks ago vs Cal with a 28-0 shutout of Colorado in Pullman (406-174 yd edge). The Wildcats meanwhile held off a stingy group of Bears LW in Berkeley in 2OT despite twice blowing 14 point leads. In LY's matchup Arizona trailed 38-7 at the half with Wazzu scoring on each of their 1st 6 possessions. While the Wildcats have a chance to prove their P12 worth the next 2 wks with a pair of ranked teams on the docket (at USC next week), we'll go ahead and call for them to come up just short here as WSU is on a 13-6 ATS run on the P12 road.

OKLAHOMA by 16 over Texas Tech - These schools set an NCAA record last year w/1,708 total yards. OU is on a 5-1 ATS series run at home. This is the lone home game in a 4 wk stretch for the Sooners, but has Bedlam on deck (1-4 ATS in game before). TT is travelling for the third time in 4 weeks and was held to a season low 336 yards last week. OU didn't allow a 2 td lead to slip away last week, instead coming back from that same deficit in an emotional and physical win at KSU. The Sooners are #1 in the FBS on OFF, averaging 206 ypg more than their foes allow. QB Mayfield is completing 74% w/a 19-2 ratio and OU is averaging 199 (5.4) rush ypg. The Red Raiders counter with our #66 pass eff D and allowed ISU to rush for 208 (5.8) last week. OU is 41-25 as a HF, but TT is 8-3 as an AD. **MISSISSIPPI by 4 over Arkansas** - UM has suffered B2B heart breaking defeats at the hands of the Razorbacks incl the LTH when Ark won in 4OT thanks to the "Henry Heave." Ole Miss not only lost LW to LSU, but also lost QB Patterson for the season. Transfer Jordan Ta'amu, who was the Conf POY at JC LY and a big surprise in press, now steps in as the starter. Ark is dealing with their own QB issues (Allen DNP LW, CS) has lost their L/3 by 30 ppg and this could be a must win for HC Bielema to save his job. This is a battle between leaky rush D's with Ole Miss allowing 261 (5.8) while Ark allows 258 (6.2) vs P5 foes. Ark is ply'g their 3rd road gm in 4 wks while UM is ply'g their 3rd str home gm. Ark is 6-3-1 as a AD while UM is 3-6 as a HF. While we do feel that Ole Miss gets a home win here, there is no line at presstime due to the status' of both tms starting QB's.

TEXAS A&M by 3 over Miss St-LY the Aggies came in ranked #4 in the 1st CFB Playoff ranking but MSU pulled the upset 35-28 (+10'). Last week we used Miss St as a 2★ on these pages, then upgraded them to a 3★ LPS and picked up a big winner with MSU beating KY 45-7 (-12, 4-2 LPS last week with our Oct GOM this weekend!). The Bulldogs avg 265 (5.7) rush ypg while A&M allows 181 (4.6). MSU is +101 ypg vs FBS foes while A&M is +16 ypg and MSU has faced a slightly tougher sked. HC Sumlin usually struggles in Oct although the Aggies are 2-0 ATS this month.

Boise St by 13 over UTAH ST - The Broncos have won 15 of the L/16 mtgs but have gone just 4-11 ATS in the process. The Aggies' only win came LTH thanks to 8 Boise TO's resulting in 35 Utah ST pts. While the Broncos continued their recent ATS woes at home, they were able to escape with a 10 pt victory over Wyoming behind a defense that surrendered just 242 ttl yds. The Aggies meanwhile turned a 28-28 HT tie into a 52-28 rout of the Rebels LW in Las Vegas (3★ LP Winner on OVER 60.5!). With the Aggies failing to cover 7 of their past 8 as a MW home dog, we'll call for the Broncos to come into Logan and get the job done!

FRESNO ST by 21 over Univ - How dominant has the Fresno St defense been so far in conf play? How about allowing just 9 ppg & 274 ypg in their 4 victories! After shutting out the Lobos 2 wks ago at home, the Bulldogs went into SDSU as a 7 pt dog and came away with a 27-3 win (375-255 yd edge). The Rebels were deadlocked at 28 going into halftime LW against Utah St before allowing the Aggies to score the final 24 pts of the game (3★ LP Winner on OVER 60.5!). While UNLV has gone a very solid 19-7 ATS as an AD, there's no question that we're siding with the upstart Bulldogs here, especially with the home team winning each of the 5 MW meetings in this series (4-1 ATS). **USF by 14 over Houston** - USF is well rested, having been home 3 of the L/4 weeks and enter with the nations longest winning streak. Houston has had halftime leads each of the L/2 weeks, but lost after allowing 38 and 42 points in the 2H. The Cougars have rushed for 239+ yards in 2 of their L/3 games, but USF is allowing just 78 (2.4) vs non option teams. The Bulls are averaging 305 (5.2) rush ypg and have scored 30+ points in a modern era record 24 straight games. USF backers deserved better last week as the Bulls had a 34-7 lead late 3Q and got backdoored w/2:45 left. The Bulls are 11-1-1 as a HF.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31ST:

Bowling Green at KENT ST - It's the Battle for the Anniversary Award. BG has won 4 straight in this rivalry (3-1 ATS) and the visitor is 4-1 ATS. Will there be any points scored? While the Falcons are dead last in the FBS on D allowing 169 ypg more than their foes average, KSU is #128 on OFF, averaging 134 ypg less than their opponents allow! BG is 40-22-1 ATS on the road, but on just a 5-14 overall ATS run. The Golden Flashes are on an 8-12 overall ATS run. Our college marquee are on a 10-4 run and this will be 2 of 2 games to choose from.

Miami Oh at OHIO - It's "The Battle of the Bricks." These two tied for the top of the MAC East last year with the Bobcats getting the Title game berth due to their 17-7 (-2') win over the Redhaws. OU is 10-1 SU/7-3-1 ATS in the series and they've gone UNDER the total in 7 of the L/8 meetings. Both schools enter off easy wins as the Bobcats remain in contention for a MAC title, while the Redhaws snapped a 3 game slide as they finally won a game under bkp QB Bahl. QB Ragland remains out indefinitely. Miami is 13-6 as an AD, while OU is 3-7 as a HF.

4★ NEW ENGLAND over LA Chargers - The Chargers head East for the 2nd time TY (27-22 win at NYG, +3 a few wks back) carrying a 3-gm winning streak after their dominating home win over DEN (all'd just 252 yds & forced 3 TO's). The Patriots meanwhile are back at home for a 2nd consec weekend and fresh off a 16 pt victory over ATL in a Super Bowl rematch from a year ago (all'd just 7 pts at home after giving up 36 ppg in the 3 grms prior TY). While the Chargers have won just 1 of their past 5 SU/ATS before their bye, the Patriots have been the polar opposite with a perfect 8-0 SU (7-1 ATS) mark prior to their week off and a 24 pt avg MOV. NE is on a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS run in this series (9 pt avg MOV) dating back to 2010 and we expect that trend to continue here.

FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 16

3★ Carolina over TAMPA BAY - Despite a big outing from a banged-up QB Winston (384 pass, 3-1 ratio), the Bucs couldn't hold onto a late lead LW in BUF as the Bills scored the game's final 10 points including the GW FG w/14 left (TB 447-434 yd edge). The Panthers had their own road struggles a week ago in the "Windy City" as while they held the Bears to just 153 yds, a pair of early offensive miscues (75 yd FR & 76 yd IR TD's) saw Chicago get the 17-3 victory. Prior to TB's 3 & 1 pt wins of a ssn ago, CAR had swept the ssn series each of the prior 3 yrs (5-1 ATS) with a 15 pt avg MOV. Despite just a 1-6 ATS mark vs NFC South foes dating back to LY, we'll go ahead and give the Panthers the 4 point edge here as the Bucs are just 2-9 ATS as a HF.

2★ Houston (+) over SEATTLE - The Texans head to the Pacific Northwest (first time visiting SEA in 12 years) following their week off (5-1 ATS after a bye) and boasting the NFL's #3 ranked scoring offense (29.5 ppg). The Seahawks meanwhile return home after a 17 point victory in NY against the Giants where they finished with a 425-174 yd edge. While the Texans have gone just 11-18-2 ATS against NFC foes and now take on the "12th Man", a 4 pt lean is all that we can give the home team in this one as Deshaun Watson (62%, 15-5 ratio) continues to be cool under pressure.

FORECAST: SEATTLE by 1

OTHER PLAYS

Miami at BALTIMORE - Thursday - The Dolphins have now rattled off 3 consec victories following their comeback home win (erased 14 pt 4Q deficit, GW 39 yd FG w/:22 left) against the Jets LW behind Matt Moore who came in for the inj'd Cutler (expected to miss here). They now head North on a short week with a solid 11-5 ATS mark as a NDIV AD. While the Ravens are just 3-13 ATS vs NDIV foes and return home after a loss in MIN where they were held to just 208 tll yds, it's worth mentioning that they've dominated this series dating back to 2008 with a 7-0 ATS (6-1 SU) mark (14 pt avg MOV). **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

† Minnesota by 14 over Cleveland - London - Following an 8 pt home win LW against the Ravens (3★ Newsletter Winner) where they nailed 6 FG's and held BAL to just 208 tll yds, the Vikings head across the pond for the 2nd time in franchise history (34-27 win over PIT in '13). The Browns meanwhile are making their 1st visit to London with more QB questions (Kessler replaced Kizer in 2H) and are sitting on just a 4-13 overall ATS run after the Titans escaped with the 12-9 victory in OT (CLE 284-269 yd edge). With CLE failing to cover 7 of their L/8 vs NFC foes and the Vikings posting an 11-3 ATS mark vs the AFC, the smart money is on MIN here as they've also gone an outstanding 8-0 ATS (7-1 SU) prior to their bye week (8 pt avg MOV).

NEW ORLEANS by 13 over Chicago - The Saints took advantage of a Rodger-less Packers squad LW in Lambeau with a 26-17 pt victory (485-260 yd edge) while also helping cash our **Top Weekly 3.5★ LP Winner on the UNDER 47!** They're now back in the Superdome boasting a 4-gm winning streak (16 pt avg MOV) to take on a Bears team that got a huge performance from rookie safety Eddie Jackson (75 yd FR TD & 76 yd IR TD) and the rest of their defense (all'd just 3 pts & 293 tll yds). While CHI is a solid 6-3 ATS prior to their bye and delivered the outright upset of the Ravens a few wks ago in BAL (+6), it's hard not to back the Saints in this one as not only are they on a 7-2 overall ATS run, but they've also owned the series dating back to '11 with a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS mark (14 pt avg MOV).

Atlanta by 2 over NY Jets - Following a 23-7 loss LW in Foxborough in their Super Bowl rematch against the Patriots (outgained 403-343, only score came w/4 min left in gm), the Falcons are back on the road again (trip to DIV rival CAR on deck) sitting at 0-3 SU & ATS against the AFC East so far in '17 (playing 4th straight non-conf gm TW). The Jets meanwhile were unable to hold onto a 14 pt lead in the 4Q as MIA hit the GW FG w/:22 left (NYJ outgained 357-272). Although the Falcons have posted a solid 8-2 ATS record away from home dating back to LY, we'll go ahead and call for the Jets to stay within the line in this one as they've gone 16-7 ATS as a HD including a pair of outright upsets vs MIA & JAX earlier TY.

PHILADELPHIA by 7 over San Francisco - After dropping 5 consec heartbreakers by 3 pts or less heading into LW, the 49ers couldn't get anything going on either end against the Cowboys who put up 40 pts & 501 yds in their easy 30 pt victory. SF now heads on the road for the 4th time in a 5 wk span (3-1 ATS away TY) to take on a high-flying Eagles squad on short rest (MNF vs WAS). PHI is sitting on a 7-2 ATS run as of presstime with a 3rd consec HG (vs DEN) and a bye on deck. While the Eagles are playing at an extremely high level and are taking on a rookie QB making his 1st career road start (Beathard 22-38-235 with a rush TD LW vs DAL), laying too many points against the 49ers has been an unwise decision so far TY following a plethora of close calls.

BUFFALO by 3 over Oakland - With some renewed confidence following their comeback win against the Chiefs last Thur, the Raiders begin a stretch of 3 road trips and a bye week over the next month of the ssn. The Bills meanwhile are in the middle of a 4-wk stretch that features 3 HG's and a quick trip to the Jets. BUF improved to 4-2 under rookie HC McDermott LW in comeback fashion (just 4th time the Bills have won 4 of first 6 during 17-yr playoff drought) as they nailed the GW 30 yd FG w/:14 left. Although the Raiders do

come in with a solid 9-3 ATS mark as an AD, the recent series history has clearly favored the home squad with a 6-0 SU record and a 7 pt avg MOV.

CINCINNATI by 14 over Indianapolis - Only HG in a 6-wk span for the Bengals as they welcome the Colts following a 15 pt loss in PIT (CIN held to just 11 FD's & 179 yds). The Colts were unable to get anything going at home against the Jaguars LW as they were shutout for the 1st time s/03 (IND sacked 10 times!). Dating back to 2002, IND has had quite a bit of success in this series with a 6-2 SU mark including a 27-0 beatdown of the Bengals in '14. While QB Brissett has been serviceable in his recent starts, a trip to "The Jungle" to take on one of the best DLs in the NFL (#9 in NFL w/18 sks) could be a risky venture.

Dallas by 3 over WASHINGTON - After an easy 30 pt win over the 49ers LW in Santa Clara where RB Elliott posted 219 yds of tll offense & 3 TD's, the Cowboys now head to the other side of the country to take on a Redskins squad that they swept a ssn ago. WAS is on short rest following their MNF battle with PHI but have gone on a 16-8 ATS run as of presstime. While the Cowboys (9-4 ATS as AF) and the Redskins (10-4 ATS as DIV HD) have posted some impressive marks in their expected roles here, we'll go ahead and take DAL in this one with the visitor shockingly having covered each of the past 6 matchups.

Pittsburgh at DETROIT - SNF - The Lions have gone a perfect 5-0 SU/ATS following their bye with 3 coming as an outright dog. The Steelers meanwhile have rattled off 2 big wins against KC and CIN (held the Bengals to just 11 FD's & 179 yds) to get back on track. Despite PIT being in a position to go all out in this matchup with a bye of their own on deck, it's worth mentioning that no lead is safe against the Lions as they're +38 pts in the 4Q so far this ssn. **Call the office on gameday at 11am ET for the Marquee Winner!**

Denver at KANSAS CITY - MNF - The Broncos are in the midst of a treacherous road trip that features a stop here to Arrowhead followed by an East Coast visit to Philly on short rest. The start of their 3-gm run away from home didn't get off to a good start LW in LA as DEN was forced into 3 TO's for a 2nd consec wk in the 21-0 shutout loss (1st time shutout s/'92, longest span among all NFL teams). The Chiefs have now dropped 2 straight following their perfect start with OAK getting a TD on the final play (KC had 2 def holding plays prior). While KC has done well as a fav with a 7-3 ATS mark, keep in mind that the Broncos have won 7 of the past 10 matchups in this series outright.
